### NEWS AND NOTES

Virginia was 2-6 going into last Sat but was outgaining their foes by over 50 ypg. They had only forced 4 TO's in the first 8 but forced 5 vs NC State and dominated game with a 446-216 yd edge despite the fact they were on the road. Virginia led 16-0 at the half missing a 22 yd FG with :16 left. They opened the 3Q with a 64/6pl drive for a td, added a 33 yd FG to make it 26-0 and coasted. Phillip Sims hit 8-10-115 but Michael Rocco also played hitting 12-23-83. An interesting play in the 1st series when they were when Sims handed off to Perry Jones and got wide open in the EZ but dropped an easy td pass. UVA scored 2pl later...ULM had been having a dream season with their upset of Arkansas, near upsets of Auburn and Baylor and an undefeated in the Sun Belt. Louisiana had struggled with Terrance Broadway at QB in their previous 2 games but piled up a 607-407 yd edge. UL led 21-10 when ULM got a 19 yd td pass with :48 left in the 1H to pull to 21-17 but UL did not let the momentum get to them. They took their opening 3Q drive 87/12 for a td and after being SOD at the ULM42 went 99/17pl for a td and a 34-17 lead. It was 34-24 when ULM was int'd at

the UL15. On the last play, UL on 4&6 opted to pass the ball with :04 left. Broadway hit Robinson with an 81 yd td pass with no time left and the xp was not attempted... Middle Tennessee and WKU played on a Thurs and MT pulled the first upset by a td-dog on the weekend. MT settled for a 19 yd FG on a 73/13pl drive to open and after a punt the teams would score td's on 4 straight poss. WKU settled for a 29 yd FG, MT on 4&1 was SOD at the WKU32 with :32 left 1H and WKU missed a 47 yd FG on the final play, 17-17. It as tied 27-27 after a 27 yd WKU FG with 6:17 left but MT had a 96 yd KR for a 7 pt lead. WKU went 57/10pl but from the 21 on FD was int'd at the 6. MT on 4&9 ran the ball into the back of the EZ for a safety on the last play, WKU finished with a 438-342 yd edge... The Army/Navy game will be played for the Commander in Chief's Trophy as Army, despite having already clinched a losing season, knocked off Air Force and can now claim the CIC Trophy with a win over Navy in the season finale. AF might not have put the same importance on the game as they're in the battle for the MW Title and Army rolled to a 41-21 win in a game they led

35-7. Army has not won the CIC Trophy since 1996. QB Trent Steelman is now 3rd in Army's career rush leaders, passing the famed Glenn Davis. While Army came in avg 383 ypg (#1 in FBS) and AF was #2 with 366 ypg, AF was limited to 103 yards rushing while Army had 314. AF had actually only punted 15 times in its first 8 games but punted 4 times here. Cody Getz ret'd for AF after missing L2W but had just 14-23 rushing (came in avg 133 ypg). Each team went on a long td drive to open and AF was SOD on 4&1 at the Army1. Army went 96/11 and settled for a 20 yd FG then Army missed a 53 yd FG. After an int Army went 53/8pl for a td and after another int, added a 36 yd FG with :03 left to lead 20-7. Army had a 265-260 yd edge at the half. With the momentum, Army went 54/12pl and 43/8pl for td's and their 3rd drive was actually SOD at the AF32 as they opened it up to a 20 pt lead after 3Q's. AF QB Deitz had a streak of 79 consecutive passes without an int end as he tossed two and he also fumbled before being int at the 1 into the EZ for a td with 2:50 left, 41-21. That came 2pl after Army was SOD at the 26. AF went 63/16pl on its final drive getting to the Army3.

# THE MOST UNIQUE POWER RATINGS IN THE COUNTRY

These Power Play Forecasts are the most unique in the country because they are based on **Northcoast Sports' Private Power Ratings**. Our ratings are unlike any computer rating, as we take into account all of the following: Strength of Opponents Individual Units (Rushing Offense and Defense, Passing Offense, & Defense, Scoring Offense and Defense, Garbage Yards, Weather, Injuries, Home Field Edge, and Successful Unbalanced Attacks). Here is how each is reflected:

**Strength of Opponent:** Our ratings do not just take the opposing team's overall power rating into account. For example, in 1992, Washington's defense vs the rush was rated at a "110" (From 1-100). They faced Colorado and allowed 183 yds rushing and **dropped 12 spots** in the national rushing defense ratings. However, Power Plays took into account the potent Buffalo run attack and had forecasted the Huskies yielding 225 yds. Due to the fact they did better than the forecast, Power Plays raised their rating to 112 even though they slipped in the national (straight yardage) rankings. Another example was Michigan vs Purdue in 1989. Michigan held Purdue to just 45 yards rushing and improved their ratings in rushing defense in the national statistics. However, our ratings had them rated at a 102 and moved them down to 99, as they should have yielded just 32 yards to an impotent Purdue rush attack. Next time an announcer on TV tells you that a certain team is #3 in the country vs the run **you better check Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings and see how good a rush defense they really have!** The top twenty ratings in Power Ratings for each offensive and defensive category will be listed in each week's issue of Power Plays.

**Garbage yards:** These are yards that a team gains or allows in the final minutes of a game when it has been decided. For example, Team A is ahead 63-0 and allows 93 yards passing for a TD vs its fourth string defense. These yards are **counted** into national ratings, **but not in Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings!**

**Weather:** If a game is played in miserable weather conditions and is low scoring, the straight statistics credit the defense with outstanding performances. Our Power Ratings reflect the conditions and do not give excess credit to the defenses.

**Injuries:** When South Carolina played NC State in 1989, South Carolina QB Todd Ellis was injured on the third play of the game. His backup, who had seen very little action all year, was not prepared and hit on just 4 of 13 passes for 65 yards. The offensive coordinator did not risk any passes. In the national statistics NC State's pass defense **MOVED UP 14 NOTCHES**. In Phil's Power Ratings they **stayed the same**, as the low yardage WAS NOT reflective of an outstanding performance by the defense.

**Home Field Edges:** The weekly projection of yards and points is weighted with the home field factored in.

**Successful Unbalanced Attacks:** In 1989, Ohio St was held to 127 yards passing vs Northwestern. This dropped OSU in the national passing offense ratings & RAISED the Wildcats in the pass defense ratings. In our ratings the two units **remained** rated the same. Why? OSU rushed for 456 yards & DID NOT HAVE TO PASS & when they did they hit 9 of 11 passes, which is VERY effective. While Northwestern's pass defense looked good in the national ratings, only Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings reflected the TRUTH!

There you have it. More than just numbers, THESE RATINGS REFLECT the true strength of each unit and allow them to have **the most accurate forecast of yards gained and points allowed in the country!** No other rating system takes into account all the previous factors. Next time you hear that a team is rated third in the country in pass defense, just remember, yards are not everything and Northcoast Sports' Power Plays will show you how strong the team really is.
