The pageantry and tradition of the Army/Navy game is just one of several reasons why CFB is our favorite sport. Navy leads the all-time series 57-49-7 and amazingly have won 11 straight dating back to former HC Paul Johnson's 1st yr. LY we used a 3★ CTOT on Under 56', an easy winner (covered by 25' pts) and also won a Marquee on Army (+7). The Knights had 26-18 FD and 418-297 yd edges but only led 13-10. Navy got a td with 4:41 left to take the lead, 17-13. Army went on a 70/11 pl drive and had a FD at the Navy 14. They appeared poised to end Navy's dominance but QB Steelman and RB Dixon botched a handoff and Navy fell on it for yet another win. Army is starting to close the gap as after Navy won the 1st 7 (6-1 ATS) in the streak by 29 ppg (+189 ypg), Army has covered 3 of the L/4 and Navy's MOV has dropped to 9.5 ppg while Army has outgained Navy in the L/3 gms by an avg of 66 ypg.

It's been the same story for Army each of the L/3 yrs as despite outgaining their foes by 38 ypg in '11, they went 3-8. In '12, despite outgaining their foes by 9 ypg they went 2-10 and now this year are 3-8 despite being only outscored by 5 ppg and outgained by 12 ypg. The rush offense continues to dominate avg 326 (5.5) but the D is all g 202 rush ypg (5.0). The backfield has dealt w/injuries and inconsistent QB play and in the L/gm Schurr came off the bench to lead 4 td drives in the 2H prompting HC Ellerson to joke when asked who will start against Navy, "That's why I close practice."

In contrast, Niumatalolo allows full media access to Midshipmen practices, and it's no secret that QB Reynolds stirs the drink for them as they are heading to their 10th bowl in 11 yrs. Reynolds has a chance here to break the NCAA single-ssn mark for rush td's as he has piled up 26 already (although 3 came in OT vs SJSU). He also has a career 17-4 ratio, which gives the Mids another dimension the other Academies lack. What has also separated the Mids from Army in their long win streak is their size adv. TY will be no different as their st'g OL avg 284 lbs and will be taking on an Army DL that avg 248. Also Navy's DL outweighs Army's OL by 19 lbs per man.

We love playing on streaks whether they be side or total and while Navy has won 11 straight, just as impressive is the streak of 7 straight UNDERS in the series with all 7 going UNDER the total by more than a td and on avg by 17 ppg. What gives us extra line value here is that option offenses generally heat up late in the ssn but these tms are very familiar with one another. Both D's see the same offense every day in practice and we have cashed multiple CTOT LPS on taking the UNDER in service academy gms through the years and will do so again here.

Only the 2011 Panthers special teams have graded worse than WAS in our rankings since 2000 which says tons about the talent on the back end as well as the coaching. This is ATL's 1st fav role since 10/20 but despite the year they are having they haven't given up on Mike Smith. PP gives ATL a 100 yd edge here and we'll side with the prediction with the Falcons at home.

TB beat BUF by 21 LW but only scored 6 pts off 5 TO's and Glennon finished with just a 40.4 QBR. TB is firmly in the spoiler role but Harbaugh will treat LW's game as a loss in practice this week and they can't let off the gas with ARZ right on their heels for the #6 seed. With just a 78 yd edge and fav's being just 6-18-1 ATS after facing SEA we'll pass on the side and lean with the Under.
