This is just the 6th mtg in Baltimore. Navy is 3-2, winning all 3 since 2000. Overall the Middies are 60-49-7, winning 14 str, but Army has covered 5 of the L7. LY for the 4th time in the L5Y Army had a chance to break their losing streak in the 4Q. We have cashed the UNDER on this play as a 3* Totals LPS 3 of the L4Y (cashed as a marquee in '14). Navy HC Niumatalolo has 8 wins over Army, surpassing George Welsh (7 from 1973-81). Neither can win the CIC Trophy as AF beat both. While Army has just 5 wins over FBS foes, they don't need a win to become bowl elig as they have the #1 APR score among 5 win tms. Army is #20 in the FBS on D, all'g 73 ypg less than their opp's avg. They allow just 289 ttl ypg incl 124 (3.9) rush. The Black Knights avg 329 (5.6) rush ypg, led by RB's Davidson & Woolfolk, who comb'd for 1,268 (5.5). While QB Bradshaw is completing just 43% w/a 4-8 ratio, he's the #2 rusher w/644 (4.1). WR Edgar Poe is the #1 rec in B2B yrs & has 292 (20.9) w/3 td's. They're well rested, as their last gm was Nov 19th vs an FCS foe. This will be Navy's 8th straight wk ply'g & LW's loss in the AAC Champ gm was costly as QB Worth, who was actually the bkp when the ssn began (entered due to inj) was inj & OFY after setting the sch'l's single ssn record for ttl yds (2,595). Also inj LW & OFY is RB Gulley, who led the tm w/a 9.9 avg (#2RB rusher 427). The new st'g QB is Soph Zach Abeys, who hadn't thrown a pass before LW (7-13-104-0-2), but did rush for 111 yds vs SMU 2 wks ago in relief. Navy is #35 in the FBS on OFF, avg 53 ypg more than their opp's allow. With 2 of their top 3 rushers out, Abeys is a solid runner & the #1RB rusher is the physical Chris High, (483, 6.5) who's 230 pounds. The #1 rec is Tillman (582, 16.6) who has more than 3X as many rec's as the #2. Against 3 common foes (AF, ND, TU) Army is 1-2 SU/ATS, -14 ppg & -119 ypg, while Navy is 1-2 SU/ATS, -12 ppg & -66 ypg. There's been 10 str UNDERS in this series w/all 10 going UNDER the ttl by more than 5 pts & on avg by 20 ppg! When Army ply'd AF a ttl of 43 pts were scored, while the Navy/AF gm had 42 pts scored. We disagree with PP and side with Army so we'll call this a No Play. **NO PLAY**

Power Plays is based upon statistical numbers and rankings that are used to develop the projections you see here.
