NEWS AND NOTES

Georgia and Alabama put on together one of the best championship games of all time. The story of this game was Bama's O-line and RB's as Eddie Lacy rushed for 181 and TJ Yeldon 153. There were a couple times where it appeared UGA was on their way to the victory but ended up coming up a few seconds short. Bama fumbled on their 2nd pass at their own 40 but UGA missed a 50 yd FG. UGA went 87/13pl for a td and led 7-0. 2 punts. Bama went 77/8pl but on 3&gl from the 5 was int'd in the EZ. Bama went 70/6pl getting a td with 1:59 left in the half then after UGA got a pair of FD's to midfield, they were int'd at the 18 and ret'd 35 yds with just 1:15 left. QB Murray was laid out after the play but no penalty was called. Bama went 42/6pl but settled for a 22 yd FG and a 10-7 halftime lead. Bama did have a 246-156 HT yd edge. UGA went 75/9pl for a td then blk'd a 49 yd FG and ret'd it 55 yds for a td and it appeared UGA was on their way to a National Title game with a 21-10 lead. On the next drive Bama's run game got them 47 of their 77 yds on the drive with the other 2pl being

a PF and a pass interference and Yeldon's 10 yd td run go them back to within 3. Bama kept it on the ground and went 74/7pl (all rushes) for a 25-21 lead but UGA answered with a 75/5pl drive, 28-25. 2 punts. Bama went 55/4pl and with UGA selling out to stop the run, McCarron hit a 45 yd td pass to Cooper which he caught in the EZ, 32-28. UGA punted with 2:17 left but forced a punt with 1:08 left using their final 2 time-outs. UGA got 4 FD's to the Alabama 8 with :15 left. The clock continued to run as they did not spike it and Murray was trying for a back shoulder fade in the EZ and threw the ball but it was deflected at the line and WR Conley, using his instinct, caught the ball. If he had let it drop, obviously the clock would've stopped and they would have had another opportunity. Instead the clock ran out... Kent St and Northern Illinois was interesting as if either team finished in the top 16 of the BCS, they would gain an automatic berth to a BCS bowl and Kent St was in the best shape coming in at #17. NI finished with a 524-260 yd edge but got off to a slow start as on their first 4

pos they punted 3 times and fumbled the PR on the other. Kent St got a 22 yd drive after the fumbled PR then after an 18 yd punt, drove 16/6pl for a 37 yd FG to lead 10-0. NI went 65/14pl, 59/6pl, 58/12pl for 2 td's and a FG but after a 34/5pl drive was int'd at the KSU3 with 2:13 left in the half. At the half NI had a commanding 240-55 yd edge but only led 17-10. Kent St went 46/8pl for a 24 yd FG and NI went 75/10pl for a 1 yd td run. NI went 43/9pl but settled for a 29 yd FG. Kent St went 31/9pl but opted to go for it on 4&7 from the NI11 but gained 5 yds. NI went on a 58/10pl drive to the KSU36 but opted to punt on 4&10. Kent St went 96/8pl, with a key 60 yd pass to Archer which got them down to the NI22. The td made it 27-20 and then NI fmbld on the next play and Kent St ret'd it 22 yds for a td with 4:38 left to tie it, 27-27. NI went 75/4pl for a td with 3:12 left and Kent St went 58/11pl for a 19 yd td pass with :44 left to force OT. Each team got a FG in the 1st OT and NI got a 23 yd run by Daniels then a 2 yd td run by Lynch. Kent St got 1 FD but on 4&8 was int'd in the EZ.

† Navy 31 Army 24 - Lincoln Financial Field, Philadelphia PA. This is the 113th meeting in one of the greatest rivalries in CFB and it used to be very evenly split with the 2 teams almost 50-50 in wins. Navy has completely taken hold of the series and has now won an amazing 10 in a row SU (by 24 ppg) and are 7-3 ATS although Army has covered 2 of the last 3 and in fact, Army has had the yardage edge each of the last 2 years (375-309 LY). This matchup has gone UNDER 6 straight yrs and LY we had a 3★ CTOT on Under 55. In the 1H Navy (-7) went 26 and 55 yds for tds after TO's and the game was tied at 14. Trailing 27-21 Army was SOD at the Navy25 with 4:31 left and then at midfield Navy lined up like they were going for it on 4th & inches and Army jumped offside. That allowed Navy to punt with :02 left. It was the 1st time the gm had been decided by 8 pts or less s/00. This yr the matchup brings extra meaning as it is the first time s/96 that both tms have a shot at the CIC Trophy. Naturally both tms beat AF as Navy (+8) won in OT 28-21 despite being outgained 507-359 (+3 TO's) and while Army snapped a 6 gm losing streak to AF winning 41-21 (+7) outgaining the Falcons 414-338 and benefitting from +5 TO's. It has been a disappointing snn for 2-9 Army (3-8 ATS) as they ret'd an unusually high # of st'rs (15) incl a 4Y starting QB in Steelman. While their rush off leads the country avg 370 ypg (5.5) and is the highest here in 20+ yrs, their #122 D has given up 439 ypg incl 238 rush ypg (5.7). Navy had been to 8 str bowls from '03-'10 but missed out LY going 5-7. Things didn't start off well at 1-3 TY, but ironically an inj to QB Miller (TO prone) in the AF gm was the best thing to happen as frosh Reynolds has led the tm to a 6-1 finish. Reynolds gives them a legitimate pass threat w/an 8-1 ratio and also leads the tm w/9 rushing tds. Both tms are evenly matched as Army is -1 ypg vs the #101 sked while Navy is +10 ypg vs the #100 sked. The difference comes on D where Navy holds a #71-122 advantage and we can't go against the recent series domination here.

The Falcons finally got the Saints monkey off their back and w/the 49ers being upset, ATL not only has the NFC South locked up but also likely a 1st round bye. With the exception of a HG vs the defending champs, ATL should cruise into the playoffs.

Harbaugh's decision to start Kaepernick backfired last week in the loss to STL. With road trips to NE and SEA, the 49ers have their work cut out for them if they want to lock up a 1st round bye for a 2nd year in a row.

Don't look now, but after a slow start, the Packers have won 6 of their L/7 gms and are getting healthier each week. The road game at CHI in 2 wks will decide the NFC North title, but even with a loss there, GB is in solid shape for at least a Wild Card.

It is not known how the Giants fared against WAS as it was a huge gm w/NFC East implications. Regardless, the G-Men have one of the toughest sked remaining of playoff contenders w/B2B road trips to ATL and BAL but they still have control of the NFC East at this time.

An OT loss at home to SEA LW was the Bears 3rd loss in the L/4 wks and now they have 3 out of 4 HG's to close out the snn. Their only HG in the stretch is against GB where they are just 1-3 against the Packers at home incl the NFC Champ gm 2Y ago.

The Seahawks grabbed a key OT road win at CHI LW. With 3 HG's in the final 4 wks at the NFL's loudest venue in CenturyLink Field, you have to think SEA is in good shape to make their 2nd playoff appearance in 3 yrs under Carroll.

No one has done more with less than 1st-yr HC Schiano but they were exposed LW at DEN before scoring the gm's final 10 pts to make it look reasonable. They do benefit from a relatively easy road down the stretch w/3 gms against losing tms and could get an ATL tm resting st'rs in the finale.

LY after their bye, MIN dropped 6 of their L/7, and now TY they have dropped 4 of their L/5 and it does not get any easier w/all 4 of their remaining tms in the playoff hunt incl home gms against division rivals CHI and GB who MIN is 0-11 against the L/3+ yrs.

Thanks to an OT win LW over SF, the Rams faint playoff hopes are still alive and their remaining 4 gms all come against tms that are in the same situation. However, 3 of those come away from home incl the finale at SEA where they have lost their L/7 by an avg of 17 ppg.

Rookie sensation RGIII has the Redskins overachieving and while it is unknown how they fared on MNF vs the NYG, WAS has played their NFC East rivals tough (3-0 ATS). They welcome in an angry BAL tm coming off a loss to PIT next wk and that could decide their fate.

It is unknown how DAL fared against PHI but w/a win they set themselves up for a final 4 gm stretch coming against 4 tms all w/playoff hopes. It helps that 3 of them come at home, but then again DAL is just 4-9 at home the L/2 yrs.

We'll give the Dolphins credit as they allowed 302 ypg their L4 while also holding the #1 offense to a season low. MIA lost #1 LT Long and which will only make SF's Smith tandem's job (20.5 sks combined) that much easier. LW Kaepernick was in free and was 8-19 on 3rd down but will be remembered for his fumbled pitch that led to a td. While the Dolphins may be settled at QB they are still only avg 302 ypg away and now a rookie will face the winds of SF Bay against a D that has 19 sacks the L/5 games. While some of the polish may have come off, it may not matter who's the 49ers QB because they've dominated foes off a SU loss going 6-0 SU and 5-1-1 ATS with an avg score of 23-4 covering by 15 ppg. The Dolphins have only been a DD AD once this year and it was against a similar team (HOU) and they lost 30-10. DD non-conf HF's are 19-9 ATS w/a 31-12 avg score in Dec and get another win here. **FORECAST: SAN FRANCISCO 34 Miami 9**

3★ CLEVELAND over Kansas City - It's obviously a difficult situation for Chiefs players and coaches this week may be more emotionally difficult than the last. Their inspired effort led them to a second win. The "KC Browns" are bringing back HC Crennel, OC Daboll, QB Quinn and RB Hillis. CLE is off a trip to OAK where they totaled a season high 475 yards as rookies Weeden (364 yds, 69%), Gordon (116 yds, 19.3) and Richardson (95 ttl yds, 4.1) are becoming a dynamic trio. They've now covered 3 straight and have been impressive at home going 3-1 SU/ATS while holding PIT, BAL and SD to 16 FD's and 263 ypg. Weeden will be linked to Quinn as each was the Browns 2nd of 2 first round DC's. The difference is that Weeden used his first 5 games (0-5 SU, 5-9 ratio) to learn from (5-3, 8-6) while Quinn who had a 10-9 ratio for CLE had an 0-4 for the Chiefs ratio TY before LW's 2-0. The Browns are a HF for the first time TY and while they were only 1-4-2 ATS in that role the L2Y they showed LW they can handle that role winning as an AF and are clearly an improving team. The Browns fans will give the Chiefs a warm welcome but once the ball kicks off, now have an excited and hungry team looking for a 5th win as a two win team with emotions that few if any have had to play with at this level. **FORECAST: CLEVELAND 24 Kansas City 9**

2★ St Louis over BUFFALO - This is one of 2 games with zero playoff implications this week and will likely be forgotten as it doesn't have the story line of KC/CLE. STL does have a slight stat edge with the #25 and #12 units (-2 TO's) vs a top 5 sked while BUF has the #17 and #24 units (-6 TO's) vs the #21 sked. This is a battle between 2 teams trending in opposite directions. BUF is on a 6-15 SU/8-13 ATS run as Fitzpatrick has tossed a 30-28 ratio over that span while the defense has allowed a 41-16 ratio. BUF's strength is their #4 ground game that has churned out 163 ypg (5.0) at home but they've only played 2 top 10 def TY (SF/ARZ). STL has their own issues at WR/OL but this is a welcome step down for Bradford after 4 games vs physical defenses. The only bad true road game he's played TY has been vs CHI and in the others he's tallied 248 ypg (64%) with a 5-1 ratio (4-0 ATS). The Rams under Fisher have become a run first team (#12) that is top 5 in sacks (32 TY) which has hold their foes on the road to 322 ypg and 3.6 ypc which spells victory at BUF in December. **FORECAST: St Louis 23 Buffalo 17**

Denver at OAKLAND - While OAK is playing for pride, DEN will be battling the rest of the season to earn one of the coveted playoff byes. DEN's wins this year have come by 14 ppg and OAK's losses have been by 17 ppg but how much energy will Manning and company expended with a trip to 9-3 BAL on deck? This play will be available at noon EST on Thursday and you can get it basically free by purchasing a Marquee 7-pack (normally \$59) for only \$49. One per subscriber with the code: Power Sweep Special. Expires 12/10/12 at 7:00 pm EST.

Baltimore 27 WASHINGTON 24 - RG3 is off B2B Nationally televised division games and while the results vs the NYG are unknown his combined numbers vs the Cowboys and the Eagles were eye catching (252 ypg, 79%, 8-1). The Skins could actually be at .500 if they won a 3rd straight but their only win at presstime vs a team that had a winning record was against MIN. The Ravens make this short trip down I-95 losing a potential AFC North clincher to their rivals and has fallen behind for homefield edge. They will still be looking for Parkway superiority as these players cross paths often. December football brings a different mentality and the Ravens have a veteran team led by a veteran QB who has led his team to 4 road wins TY throwing only 2 int in the L/5 games and has led them to the playoffs in each of his 4 seasons. The Raven's injury maligned D allowed 23 ppg their first 7 but since the bye and the return of Suggs they are #1 in the NFL the L5W allowing only 16.2 and also may see Ray Lewis in some spot duty. This is an example of learning to win versus knowing to win.

PITTSBURGH 27 San Diego 14 - PIT not only upset the Ravens LW but may now get the return of Big Ben. On the flip side the boom you heard on the West Coast may have been the Chargers organization imploding after a 4th straight loss and the 6th on the season with the line between +3/-3. The Chargers are 1-6 SU/ATS in EST games with the only win vs JAX LY for a 29-17 avg score in the losses. The Chargers are paying for their inability to protect Rivers whose 36 sacks are only behind Rodgers 39 sacks TY. That along with not getting a true #1 WR has seen Rivers only avg 24.7 ypg (65%) w/a 18-15 ratio despite playing 1 team (DEN) with a def in the top half of the league. LY SD had twice (42) as many offense/spec tms td's vs 3&outs (21) and this year they have just 22 off/spec tms td's vs 38 3&outs. PIT is allowing an NFL best 242 ypg/12.4 ppg at home TY and have held Dalton, Eli and Flacco led offenses to under 200 yds TY. While both teams have beat up OL's the Steelers are sounder on defense and getting healthier (Polamalu, & WR Brown) and we'll call for the home team by 13 here.

INDIANAPOLIS 28 Tennessee 20 - In their first meeting Luck led his team to a season high 30 FD's and got his first NFL road win throwing a 16 yd td pass to Ballard in OT. LW they stunned DET and now home where they've won and covered 4 straight beating GB, CLE, MIA and BUF while out'FD each of them by 5.5 per game. Luck who has struggled away (8-13 ratio) has 9-3 ratio at home and after throwing for 53% in Sept and 57% in Oct he tossed for 59% in Nov. Now the improving rookie faces a Titans D allowing 70% on the year and has the leagues #31 D QBR with a 24-10 ratio. The Colts D get very little publicity but they are only allowing 334 ypg at home with their high being only 365 yards. That is a big part of why their the ONLY team in the NFL to have outgained their L7 foes. The Titans struggled against a physical Texans D and with Locker (6.9 ypa 57% 8-7 ratio) operating with a new OC having lost their starting RT expect the Colts to dial up blitzes to keep him out of rhythm and make RB Johnson a non-factor.

NY Jets 19 JACKSONVILLE 9 - Mark Sanchez threw multiple picks the L/3 games so let's get Tebow to help out the QB spot. This Tebow guy is inj'd and some say a distraction so let's make him inactive. Oh well, Sanchez threw multiple int's for the 6th time in 15 games so what do we do know? We'll bring in McElroy to a standing ovation and he led the Jets to more yards (150) on 4 drives than Sanchez did prior (139) along with a td. NY has taken to the road twice against losing teams and did win and cover vs both MIA and STL. The Jets D showed what their capable against a weak offense allowing ARZ FIVE FD's and 137 yds. The Jag's continue on their pace to finish dead last in both offense and defense getting outgained 344-236 LW and they've now been outgained in every game TY with the exception of GB. The Jaguars did win a game at home TY thanks to +3 in TO's but in their 5 losses the avg score was 31-9. The Jets have a solid edge on defense and like BUF LW are used to Henne and we'll call for the road team by 10 here.

Chicago 23 MINNESOTA 20 - The Bears have won and covered 6 straight vs MIN with a 31-15 avg score. CHI won the previous meeting 2 wks ago 28-10 as 6 pt HF. CHI paid a heavy toll as they lost both starting OG's (RG Louis for year), WR Hester (concussion) with #1 RB Forte and #1 CB Tillman (foot) leaving as well. Ponder has TOTALED 286 yds (50%) w/a 1-2 ratio in 3 starts vs CHI while Cutler has avg'd 218 ypg (66%) w/a 14-7 ratio with CHI vs MIN. CHI is 2-8-1 ATS off a home loss as the defense gave up 97 and 80 yd td drives to a rookie QB in his 2nd straight road game. This is a huge game for CHI as they host GB next week and these div wins may decide the champion. MIN has the edge with their #13 pass rush at home on turf vs an OL that is 28th with 36 sacks (1 every 10.4 atts) so far. However, MIN has been very limited without Harvin (ankle) and Peterson has been held to under 95 yds rushing in 4 of the L5 meetings. We'll call for the Bears by 3 as due to key injuries for both teams will let the line be the deciding factor.

Atlanta 28 CAROLINA 27 - ATL has won 5 straight covering 4 but the Panthers had the Falcons on the ropes in the 1st meeting until Newton fumbled on 3rd down at mid-field which they recovered and then punted. Ryan hit a 59 yd pass to White and 5 plays later ATL hit the game winning FG with 10 sec left. Ryan has avg'd 242 ypg (61%) with a 15-5 ratio vs CAR while Newton has been fairly contained by ATL behind held to 243 ypg (56%) with a 4-5 ratio and 172 yds rushing (7.8). ATL has extra rest but fav's off a Thur game are only 4-5 ATS TY and ATL has actually been outgained by an avg of 5 ypg TY in Div play. CAR is off a loss to an inspired KC team and while Newton didn't play badly (232 yds 56% 3-0) he doesn't have much of a supporting cast as the rest of the team had 87 yds rushing (5.8) and 7 of 8 rec's had less than 50 yds receiving. CAR's DL woes are catching up to them again as they have allowed 176 ypg rushing (5.3) the L3W with just 4 sacks total over the L4W (16-8 ratio). ATL has a big game vs the Giants on deck and have already wrapped up the NFC South and will be more interested in avoiding injuries. We'll call for the road team by 1 in a higher scoring game.

TAMPA BAY 38 Philadelphia 17 - This a horrible situation for PHI as this is the only non-prime-time game in a 4 week span and their 3rd road game in a 4 week stretch. This is a huge break for TB as in the L4W they've given up 296 ypg (72%) w/a 8-4 ratio to Rivers, Newton, Ryan and Peyton they get a rookie QB behind a beat up OL missing his top WR (Jackson 45 rec 15.6). Freeman has far outplayed TB's 3-2-1 ATS mark at home with 280 ypg (62%) w/a 10-2 ratio. This accounts for the fact that RB Martin has yet to crack 100 yds rushing at home TY (68 ypg 4.0) but PHI is allowing 126 ypg (4.3) rushing away. PHI erred greatly when they made Bowles the DC as since the bye they've given up a Raider-esque 243 ypg (75%) w/a 13-0 ratio and only 11 sacks vs 235 ypg (52%) w/a 7-7 ratio prior. TB is in a heated battle for the final NFC wild-card and while the line is a bit inflated here the Bucs are the play.

Dallas 23 CINCINNATI 20 - The Bengals are trying to clinch the NFC East after having already beaten the NYG and Washington. CIN took a 3 game winning streak into SD and the defense overcame Dalton's struggles on the day. The Cowboys meanwhile are off a SNF vs PHI and a win keeps their playoff hopes intact but getting upset as DD fav vs a rival on a 7 game losing streak would be another story. On paper this is a mismatch with the Cowboys only 1 of 3 teams (HOU & DEN) that rank in the top 10 of both off and def and they've outgained their foes by 47 ypg vs the #6 sked while CIN has outgained their foes by 26 ypg but versus the #30 sked. However, taking a look at the Cowboys L6 games their 3 losses were to WAS, ATL and the Giants while in their 3 wins they were outgained by 7 yards vs CAR, outgained by 75 yds vs PHI and only outgained CLE by 9 yards. The Cowboy's offense has missed Murray (expected limited time LW) as in the 2 games he rushed 18+ times they won both and in the other 9 games Romo has avg an astounding 44 att's per game incl 112 in the 2 games prior to Philly. We'll back the Cowboys who are 10-4 as an AG against CIN returning from the West Coast with their 4-12 home favorite record. Murray's return would be a boost.

NY GIANTS 31 New Orleans 24 - Even though the Saints have the extra rest while the Giants are off a MNF NY has an edge as they are familiar with DC Spagnuolo's defense and the fact that NO doesn't have the right players for it. Brees had a career worst game LW with 5 ints and NO is 0-4 SU/ATS when Brees tosses 2 or more ints TY. It's well documented that Giants are a poor HF (8-19 ATS) but the Saints are 0-3 SU and 1-2 ATS as an AD TY. Over the L/6 game the Saints are 3-3 but the offense is clearly missing the adjustments that Payton made as the season progressed as they've avg'd 362 ypg. NO has improved their yards allowed in 3 straight games but the L/2 are misleading as both ATL and SF went vanilla with the lead. The Giants are very beat up on the defensive side as JPP, Tuck, Safety Phillips were all beat up prior to WAS which would be great news for Brees who has to play a perfect game for NO to win. Dogs off a Thur game are a decent 13-11 ATS the L2Y and we'll call for the Giants by a TD right now in a higher scoring game and wait for the practice report for both teams.

SEATTLE 21 Arizona 6 - ARZ started the season 4-0 with an off avg 23 ppg but since that time they've lost 8 straight never reaching 20 points in any game while avg 11.5 ppg. Now they travel to face the league's #5 D playing with revenge for a season opening loss. In that game SEA had 1&gl on their final drive but were SOD. Wilson continues to gain confidence as LW he led a 80'12pl drive scoring with 7:33 left in OT to upset CHI and now gets to see the same defense as his first ever NFL game in which he was 18-34. Ryan Lindley gets no such luck with ARZ playing its 3rd road game in 4 weeks and despite not having faced a D ranked higher than #13 he's thrown for 125 ypg (56%) w/a 0-4 ratio. The Cards OL started 2 rookies and a 1st time center LW and they were held to 5 FD and 137 yds in the loss to the NYJ. Now they face a relentless SEA pass rush that is #10 in sks by and allowed. While SEA is a DD fav for the 1st time s/09 we're not afraid to lay the pts here as the Seahawks have won 5 straight at home covering them all by 11 ppg.

Detroit at GREEN BAY - Sunday Night - This is the Packers 5th primetime game this season but only the 2nd one at home. While GB would never lose a div foe with each win vital, they do have CHI on deck for the possible NFC North championship. The Lions are relegated to the role of spoiler but to pull the upset it would take beating their first winning team on the road this season! NFL Marquee's are 22-10 69% and this play can be yours for \$12 through our office, \$9 on the NC Sports debit card or as little as \$7 on the Marquee 7-pack.

Houston at NEW ENGLAND - Monday Night - A possible #1 seed could be on the line. These 2 last met in the 2009 season finale as Houston scored three 4Q td's against the Pat's 2nd string as NE had a #1 seed wrapped up. Both teams excel in games vs similar match teams as Houston is 10-3-1 ATS with the line between +5 & -5 while NE is 8-2 ATS in that same role. The Texans are 1-0 SU/ATS as a dog (+1 Chi, 13-6) while the Patriots are 2-0 SU/ATS TY as a SD HF. The MN Magic and Marquee are both available after Noon EST gameday.
