## KEY SELECTION

### Big 10 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME • LUCAS OIL STADIUM • INDIANAPOLIS, IN

**3★ † Ohio St over Michigan St** - OSU has won 8 of the L/9 in the series and has covered 6 of the L/8. In 2008 we used our 5★ Oct GOM on OSU (-3) and they delivered a 45-7 win. In 2011 MSU had 24 Ohio natives on its roster (27 this year!) and upset the Buckeyes 10-7 (+3) at the Shoe. LY OSU ret'd the favor winning 17-16 (+2) LY at MSU. TY's B10 champ gm is easily the most important B10 gm since #1 OSU beat #2 UM back in 2006. A win here puts the Buckeyes in the BCS Champ gm while MSU looks to be in good shape for their 1st Rose Bowl appearance s/87 win or lose. The Buckeyes come in winners of 24 str gms (longest streak s/ USC '03-'05) but LW had to hold on for dear life over archrival UM 42-41 (-16) getting an int on a 2-pt conv w/:32 left. It will be Irresistible Force vs Immovable Object here as the Buckeye ground gm is arguably the best in the country avg 321 ypg (7.0) and will be taking on a MSU rush D that is all'g just 65 ypg (2.2). The Spartans finished an unbeaten B10 season for the 1st time s/66 beating Minnesota 14-3 (-16) LW. While they have held 5 of their L/6 opp w/o a td, that one opp, Neb, was one of the better offenses they faced TY (#39). They all'd 28 pts and 392 yds incl 182 on the ground and won the gm due to 5 Husker TO's. Now they take our #4 off that is avg 48 ppg and 531 ypg. Meyer has the big gm exp, the Bucks had a wake-up call LW, now face a QB that can't beat them w/his legs and their pass rush can tee off on MSU QB Cook (avg 4.6 sks per gm L/5). OSU heads to Pasadena and we're not talking about playing on January 1st.

## OTHER SELECTION

### PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME • SUN DEVIL STADIUM • TEMPE, AZ

**2★ Stanford over ARIZONA ST** - This is the only rematch this year in a championship gm as Stanford beat Arizona ST 42-28 (-6) back in mid-Sept on the Farm. The gm should go down as a misleading statistical gm. Some may point out that Ast had a 417-391 yd and 20-19 FD edge but all you had to do was watch the 1H of the gm. SU absolutely dominated with a 256-103 yd edge and led 29-0 at the half. They extended it to 39-7 before they put the backups in and Ast got 197 of their yds on 3 td drives. We easily cashed our Button #9 NCSportsline Comp Totals play on the OVER. We also leaned with Stanford in the write-up prior to the gm calling them to win by DD's as they have won 3 str in the series (2-1 ATS). This is Stanford's 2nd str P12 Champ gm as they beat UCLA 27-24 (-9) LY. However, that gm was at home and this will be on the road. LW they beat ND 27-20 (-15) as they dominated the LOS w/a 261-64 rush yd edge. Speaking of domination, the Sun Devils turned LW's Territorial Cup into a run away w/a 58-21 win (-11) over Arizona. However, it should be noted that Ast only had 22-20 FD and 478-424 yd edges as they benefitted from 4 UA TO's. They are 7-0 SU/5-2 ATS at home TY outscoring their opp by an avg of 49-21 (+156 ypg). This is only the 3rd time Stanford has been an AD in the L/3 yrs. They are 1-0-1 ATS in that role taking a ND tm that played in the BCS Champ gm LY to OT before losing 20-13 (+7) and then upsetting #1 Oregon 17-14 (+20) in OT. They have more exp in big-time gms, have our #3 D and will benefit from an Ast tm most likely playing w/o RB Marion Grice (DNP LW) who leads the tm in rushing, is #3 in rec and has 20 td's.

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY, DECEMBER 5TH

**Louisville at CINCINNATI** - The Battle for the Keg of Nails. This will be the last gm played at Nippert Stad before it is renovated and expanded (Cincy will play HG's at Paul Brown in '14) and will also be the last meeting for these 2 rivals w/UL moving off to the ACC next yr. Cincy is 4-1 SU/ATS but the visitor is 7-1 ATS. LY UL was -3' at home and only won 34-31. UC led the majority of the game but Munchie Legaux hit 13-28-157 w/3 int while Teddy Bridgewater hit 24-41-416 on a cold, windy, rainy night. UC led 24-14 in the 3Q but the game went to OT and UC was int'd at the GL. UL had a bad snap on their FG and couldn't get it off but HC Jones called TO so they kicked the game winner on the next play. Tuberville at home vs ranked tms is 11-9-1 ATS s/01 but has pulled 10 outright upsets incl 9 over Top 10 tms! UC remarkably would win the AAC here w/a win and a UCF loss as they would finish higher in the BCS rankings. These two tms have played 6 common opp (Conn, Hou, Mem, Rut, Temp and USF). UL is 6-0 SU/1-5 ATS w/an avg line of 23 (all fav) as they are outscoring those foes by an avg of 27-0 (+196 ypg). Cincy is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS w/an avg line of 8 (2 dog) as they are outscoring those foes by an avg of 35-20 (+187 ypg). These two tms are very similar as both have accurate QB's in UL's Bridgewater who is comp 71% w/a 25-3 ratio while UC's Kay is comp 70% w/a 22-9 ratio. Both tms have great rush D's as Cincy is all'g 92 ypg (3.0) while UL is all'g 83 ypg (2.7). UL has the more talented tm but Tuberville is dangerous at home.

### FRIDAY, DECEMBER 6TH

#### MAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME • FORD FIELD • DETROIT, MI

**† Northern Illinois vs Bowling Green** - BG leads the all-time series 10-7. These two have played each other 7x's as MAC rivals w/BG going 3-1 SU/ATS the 1st 4 while NIU is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS the L/3 incl a 45-14 (-5) win over BG in their last meeting. NIU is playing their 4th str MAC Champ gm and while they are going for a 3-peat here, all-time they are 0-4 ATS in the champ gm. BG is 0-1 SU/ATS in the MAC champ losing 49-27 (+7) to #13 Miami, Oh in 2003. The dog has covered 5 str MAC champ gms incl 2 outright upsets and since it moved here to Ford Field in 2004, the dog is 7-2 ATS (3 upsets). Despite playing in opp div, these 2 have played 5 common opp (Kent, Akron, UMass, UT and EMU). NIU is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS w/an avg line of 18 and have outscored those opp by an avg of 44-20 (+218 ypg). BG is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS w/an avg line of 16 and have outscored those opp by an avg of 37-16 (+202 ypg). BG comes in red-hot with 4 str wins/covering outscoring their L/4 opp by 40 ppg (+314 ypg). NIU completed their 1st unbeaten reg ssn in 50 yrs and QB Lynch in his last gm reset his own NCAA-record w/321 rush yds. They have now won a MAC-rec 25 str gms and have won 24 str reg ssn gms. While NIU has the offensive edge (#20-59), BG counters w/a #23-77 D edge and also an #18-31 ST's edge. The Falcons are 15-8 ATS as an AD s/'08 and the BG rush D is all'g just 57 ypg the L/4 gms incl shutting down the MAC's best RB LW (Oliver 46 yds). Can they do what no other MAC tm has done the L/2 yrs and shut down Lynch and Co?

### SATURDAY, DECEMBER 7TH

**CONNECTICUT by 4 over Memphis** - First meeting. Memphis finishes off the season with its 3rd AG in 4 wks, while Conn is in their FHG and were at home last week. The Huskies come in on a bit of a roll w/B2B wins after cashing an 8th outright upset winner in the L/11 wks for our NC Sportsline Underdog POW (given out FREE every Tue on Button #3 at 347-677-1700) by beating Rutgers 28-17 (+2). The big diff in their turnaround has come at the QB spot as Cochran was 25-33-311-2-0 LW. Their run D also has performed well all'g 87 rush ypg in the L/4 gms. On the other side, Mem, off B2B wins, was looking to end the ssn on a high note, but LW were destroyed by Temple 41-21 (-8) getting outFD'd 23-16 and outgained 534-228. Prior to that gm the D was all'g just 21 ppg and 338 ypg. Both tms have covered 3 of their L/4 gms but after LW we'll be more than happy to back an underdog Husky tm at home for the 2nd consec wk who is 8-3-1 ATS in their FHG and 18-4 ATS as a HD.

**RUTGERS by 7 over Usf** - Rutgers is 6-1 SU and has also covered 6 straight pulling the outright upset 5x. USF is a Florida team playing in New Jersey in December! LTH USF led 17-3 w/7:38 left but missed a 27 yd FG as time exp'd and eventually lost in OT. LY USF had 4 TO's and missed out on several scoring opportunities in a 23-13 loss (-7) as they fell to 0-9 all-time on Thursday nights. TY the Knights come in reeling losers of 5 of their L/6 gms and they have failed to cover 5 str gms after LW's 28-17 loss (-2) to UConn. The switch to Dodd at QB didn't jump start the offense as he was just 16-35-286-0-2 and the ground gm is struggling avg just 79 ypg the L/4 wks. Speaking of struggling on offense, the Bulls are avg just 14 ppg and 261 ypg TY ranking in the bottom 5 in the NCAA in both categories. LW they took adv of 5 UCF TO's and nearly pulled a huge upset before falling 23-20 (+26'). QB White after a solid debut continues to struggle w/a 1-7 rating in his L/4 starts. This one pretty much comes down to motivation: Knights are playing their FHG needing a win to get to their 8th bowl in 9 yrs while the Bulls just gave maximum effort trying to upset their Top 20 in-state rival LW and are now travelling to the cold w/nothing at stake.

**BAYLOR by 7 over Texas** - UT had won 12 in a row SU in this series by 37 ppg. They were upset in '10 (-7) at home, 30-22, then in '11 were a 3 pt dog (first time dog s/'94) and lost by 24. LY they were -8' at home playing with legit double revenge and were -8'. UT had leads of 42-31 and 56-43 but BU went 94/15pl and on 4&gl got a 1 yd td run with 1:57 left for the backdoor cover. Baylor is 18-1 SU/16-2 ATS at home and 12-2 ATS as a HF. Texas, however has a far better record on the road (39-8) than at home (53-15) s/'03 and are on a 8-2 ATS run as an AD (neutral not incl) s/'98. LW we cashed our Thanksgiving Marquee on a Texas tm coming off a bye as they crushed TT 41-16 (-4'). It was the Horns 7th win in the L/8 gms and they can still win the B12 outright w/an upset here and an OU win. Their D managed 9 sks LW and now has 33 in the 8 gms under DC Robinson while all'g just 8 sks in the same time frame. Baylor is playing a 5th str week and are off a 3-gm road trip. LW it was a classic Bubble Burst spot following the loss to OST, they travelled to take on a rested TCU tm. To say the Bears were extremely fortunate to come away w/a win is an understatement as they benefitted from 4 costly TCU TO's incl 2 long IR td's that, at minimum, were both 10-pt swings and they got an int in the EZ in the final seconds. In the end they failed to cover as a 13' pt AF (41-38). They are now laying around the same number to a UT tm that dismantled TCU earlier TY. This is not only Baylor's FHG (9-13-1 ATS) but the final game for Floyd Casey Stadium as they move into a new stadium next year so they will give a great effort. However, that effort won't be good enough to cover another inflated point spread as this is the largest dog role UT has been in s/'98 and in that gm an unranked UT tm upset a #7 Nebraska tm 20-16 (+16').

**Louisiana by 6 over SOUTH ALABAMA** - LY UL had a 538-414 yd edge and only led 17-16 when they got a td with :16 left in the half to go up 24-16. USA got a 28 yd td pass with 7:26 left but UL rec'd the onside kick, went 47/6pl and got a 1 yd td run with 3:33 left for the frontdoor cover, 52-30 (-18'). UL is off instate rival ULM but they've gone 4-0 ATS the foll'g wk. LW they were in their largest favorite role in the series in 15+ yrs. We cashed a 2★ Selection on these pages and a Big Dog POW (24 this year!) on the Warhawks (+14') in their 31-28 upset. The Ragin' Cajuns shot themselves in the foot as they had 26-16 FD and 471-394 yd edges but couldn't overcome 3 int's by QB Broadway who was KO'd (CS). His bkp Brooks Haack was 10-14-126-1-0 and according to Hudspeth is a "true passer that has some mobility." Despite the loss, UL will at least share the SB title because of Ark ST's loss to WKU. After a tough start to the ssn which saw the Jaguars lose 5 gms by a total of 12 pts, they have now won B2B by a total of 43 pts. They are just 1 win away from bowl elig in just their 2nd yr of FBS play. LW they rolled up 24-15 FD and 522-345 yd edges in a 38-17 win (-7) over GSt. As of presstime there is no line w/Broadway ?, but we're not going to overreact as he was a main culprit in LW's loss and UL had been, by far, the most complete and dominant tm in SBC in their prev 6 gms.

**Ucf by 7 over SMU** - The HT has won 4 in a row SU but UCF is 4-1 SU (3-1-1 ATS). LTH ('11) SMU was -3' and rolled to a 38-17 win. LY UCF was -9' at home and got their revenge 42-17. While you have to give the Knights credit for continuing their quest towards a BCS bowl in their 1st yr of AAC play, pressure has certainly started to show. They have failed to cover 3 of their L/4 gms incl LW's 23-20 (-26') win over USF. They uncharacteristically had 5 TO's and had to get a long td pass in the final minutes to pull out the win. On the other side, after winning/covering 4 of their L/5 gms, SMU found life very tough w/o QB Gilbert as they were blanked by Houston 34-0 (+9'). It was the 1st time SMU had been shutout s/'04 and also the 1st time in June Jones' HC career that he was shutout in a gm. Burcham was 27-52-212-0-3 and as of presstime it is unknown whether or not Gilbert will be back for this gm. What is known is that UCF is 1-6 as a conf AF the L/2 yrs while SMU is 7-3 as a HD the L/4 yrs. It also should be noted that w/a Louisville win on Thursday night, UCF could already have a BCS bowl bid locked up here w/nothing to play for while SMU needs a win to get to their 5th straight bowl and have gone 17-2 SU at home vs conf opp.

**OKLAHOMA ST by 7 over Oklahoma** - Oklahoma won 8 straight before losing the LTH (OU #13, OSU #3) in an embarrassing game where they appeared to quit in the 1H (+3, 10-44). In fact, OSU was the higher ranked team in '09, '10 & '11. OU was also 5-0-1 ATS but have now dropped B2B ATS. LY they were at home -6' playing with legit revenge but shockingly never led during regulation. They had to overcome DD deficits in both halves getting a big play at the end of the 1H and a big play at the end of the game to force OT and won 51-48. Both tms come in off byes. Cowboys are now 15-4-1 ATS as a conf HF s/'07 while this will be only the 5th time Sooners are a conf AD in the L6Y (2-2 ATS). They did win outright 2 wks ago in this role upsetting KSt 41-31 (+5). Knight took over the QB duties mid-2Q vs ISt (Bell inj'd) and in the L/6 Qtr's they have scored a combined 79 pts while piling up 706 rush yds in the L/2 gms (7.4). In B12 play, OU is actually +50 ypg while OST is +40 ypg. The Cowboys have won 7 str gms and covered each of their L/6 and with a win here will wrap up their 3rd 11-win ssn in 4 yrs. In their L/gm they cashed as both a B12 and Big Dog POW in their dominating 49-17 upset (+8') of previously unbeaten Baylor. QB Chelf, in each of the L/2 gms, has arguably played the game of his life incl a 19-25-370-3-0 performance vs the Bears. While it's tough to go against a team that is so dominating at home and is on a 6-gm ATS streak, LW proved to us that you need to be wary of the dog in a big rivalry gm (see Auburn, Michigan, Oregon St).
