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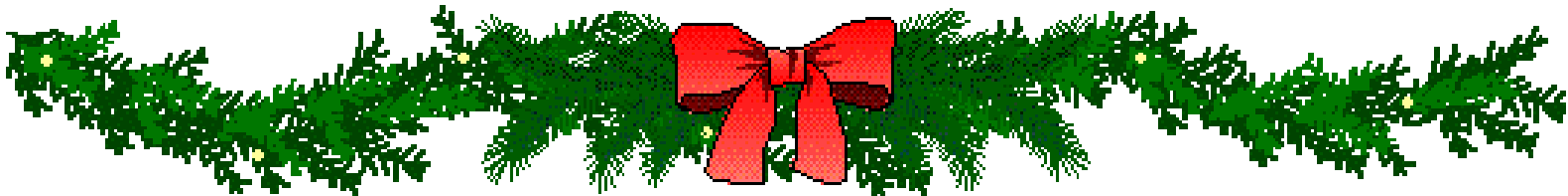

The pageantry and tradition of the Army/Navy game is just one of several reasons why CFB is our favorite sport. Navy leads the all-time series 57-49-7 and amazingly have won 11 straight dating back to former HC Paul Johnson's 1st yr. LY we used a 3★ CTOT on Under 56', an easy winner (covered by 25' pts) and also won a Marquee on Army (+7). The Knights had 26-18 FD and 418-297 yd edges but only led 13-10. Navy got a td with 4:41 left to take the lead, 17-13. Army went on a 70/11 pl drive and had a FD at the Navy 14. They appeared poised to end Navy's dominance but QB Steelman and RB Dixon botched a handoff and Navy fell on it for yet another win. Army is starting to close the gap as after Navy won the 1st 7 (6-1 ATS) in the streak by 29 ypg (+189 ypg). Army has covered 3 of the L/4 and Navy's MOV has dropped to 9.5 ypg while Army has outgained Navy in the L/3 gms by an avg of 66 ypg.

It's been the same story for Army each of the L/3 yrs as despite outgaining their foes by 38 ypg in '11, they went 3-8. In '12, despite outgaining their foes by 9 ypg they went 2-10 and now this year are 3-8 despite being only outscored by 5 ypg and outgained by 12 ypg. The rush offense continues to dominate avg 326 (5.5) but the D is all g 202 rush ypg (5.0). The backfield has dealt w/injuries and inconsistent QB play and in the L/gm Schurr came off the bench to lead 4 td drives in the 2H prompting HC Ellerson to joke when asked who will start against Navy, "That's why I close practice."

In contrast, Niumatalolo allows full media access to Midshipmen practices, and it's no secret that QB Reynolds stirs the drink for them as they are heading to their 10th bowl in 11 yrs. Reynolds has a chance here to break the NCAA single-ssn mark for rush tds as he has piled up 26 already (although 3 came in OT vs SJSU). He also has a career 17-4 ratio, which gives the Mids another dimension the other Academies lack. What has also separated the Mids from Army in their long win streak is their size adv. TY will be no different as their stg OL avg 284 lbs and will be taking on a Army DL that avg 248. Also Navy's DL outweighs Army's OL by 19 lbs per man.

We love playing on streaks whether they be side or total and while Navy has won 11 straight, just as impressive is the streak of 7 straight UNDERS in the series with all 7 going UNDER the total by more than a td and on avg by 17 ypg. What gives us extra line value here is that option offenses generally heat up late in the ssn but these tms are very familiar with one another. Both D's see the same offense every day in practice and we have cashed multiple CTOT LPS on taking the UNDER in service academy gms through the years and will do so again here.

4★ Kansas City by 13 over OAKLAND - It's a difficult scenario when you start a season 9-0, then lose 3 straight and have to go on the road for B2B trips. Most teams might have faded but Andy Reid's leadership is what is different about KC TY. In the first meeting TY Chiefs fans set a world record for crowd noise and KC needed the help as they were outgained 274-216 but got 55/5pl and 23/4 pl TD drives as well as a 44 yd pick 6. Now they take a 5-1 SU/ATS road record to face an OAK squad who has dropped 4 of 5 SU despite playing the #31 schedule in that span. Chiefs have covered all 3 as an AF TY by 12 ppg after not having been one LY and Reid takes care of business in div road games as at PHI the Eagles went 7-2 ATS as an AF or dog of 3 or less with the non covers in gm #16 with nothing to play for a 3 pt win laying 3'.

3★ CAROLINA by 17 over NY Jets - We were a week early calling for the Jets as they were outgained 453-177 vs Miami losing 23-3 but then LW knocked off Oakland 37-27 being outgained by 32 yds. The one constant is when the Jets travel you either play against them or pass. Eliminating a head case Atlanta team NY is 0-5 SU and 1-4 ATS failing to top 14 points in ANY game getting outgained by 100 ypg their L/3. That's what happens when you have a rookie QB that had a road ratio of 4-12 with a 14.0 sack%. The only thing that could be bad for the Jets this week is facing a quality defense (CAR #2), that very well could be off a Nat'l TV division loss (Car 7-1 ATS home off SU loss) and perhaps the most points they've allowed all year (gave up 20+ 3 times & the next week allowed a combined 26 pts). The Panthers who are #2 in sacks will wreak havoc and under Rivera, Carolina is now a perfect 6-0 ATS when favored by 6 or more, covering by 11 ppg.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Arizona by 7 over TENNESSEE - Titans supporters will say that LW's game was an outlier and that they've done well outside of Manning's 397 yds (66%) with 4 td's. While this was only the 2nd time TY that they've given up multiple passing td's (HOU with 3 in Wk 2) the Titans also haven't faced many quality passing teams. TEN simply lacks the big play firepower and Fitzpatrick has 225 or less yds passing in 3 of his L4 starts which combined with Munchak's conservative coaching has hurt them (outscored 75-44 in 3rd Qtr). Palmer (elbow) sat out most of LW but vs a similarly structured STL defense was efficient with 269 yds (84%) and a td. Ariens knows what he's facing after coaching the Colts LY as ARZ posted 27, 27 and 40 vs the other AFC South teams (2-0-1 ATS). With ARZ having won the yardage battle in 10 of 13 games TY (8-1-1 ATS), all g just 84 ypg rushing (3.6), and #6 in sacks by with a decent QB edge (Fitzpatrick had 180 yds 52% 1-1 vs IND LY) we'll take the road team with a manageable line here.

OTHER GAMES

San Diego at Denver (Thursday) - FHG for DEN and still have much to play for chasing the Patriots. Feeling that pressure since the break DEN is still 4-1 SU/ATS but have covered those wins by only 1, 3 and 1 and trailed at HT last week. Can San Diego put 2H's together as they are 6-7 SU but have led or been tied at HT in 11 games TY. Will Denver move to 6-0 SU and 5-1 ATS (L by ½ pt) vs AFC West teams or will San Diego NOT cover in Denver for the FIRST TIME IN 10Y (6-0-3 ATS)!

ATLANTA by 9 over Washington - LY's #1 and #4 playoff seeds. When you start a season 2-8 SU/ATS Vegas needs to continue inflating the numbers to balance the books. Falcon backers have now benefited with 3 straight covers but ATL continues to struggle, this time getting shutout in the 2H failing to capitalize on a 21-10 HT lead. WAS has a coach and QB with a relationship similar to Harbaugh and Carroll and WAS is now 3-10 SU/ATS. The big edge for ATL is Ryan with an offense starting to get better vs the #27 pass def that's given up 70% comp with an 8-3 ratio the LSW with 3 straight home losses where they gave up 32 ppg. WAS offense which is avg 12 ppg the L/4 managed just ONE drive LW with over 2 FD's (4) and that was at home vs KC's #21 D. WAS has failed to cover 4 straight on the road and we'll take the home team who still believes in their coach in a higher scoring game here.

San Francisco by 10 over TAMPA BAY - TB has won/covered 3 straight at home (11-25 SU/10-25-1 ATS prior) but they've done it vs a MIA team with major off field issues, a depleted ATL team and BUF off a tough loss to ATL travelling for the 2nd straight. TB forced 5 BUF TO's but only got 3 pts off them (and were helped out by 114 penalty yds) and teams have caught onto Glennon who's gone from a 138.4 OBR vs DET to 73.5 vs CAR to just 40.4 vs BUF. Now he takes on the #4 D that is all g just 223 ypg (58%) with a 13.4 ratio the LSW. TB is all g 122 ypg (4.9) rushing the L4W and now face a dedicated power rushing team. While SF disappointed us LW, the Bucs win combined with a close, confidence boosting win over a tough div rival by SF who takes a step down in class here as we call for the road team to win by double digits here.

New Orleans by 13 over ST LOUIS - Saints face 3rd straight physical defense off of SEA, CAR and have CAR on deck. STL lost C Wells and LW. In the first game w/o him the offense scored 10 pts and put up only 257 yards. While the rush attack may have gained 100 yds LW, 56 of it came on a run by WR Austin (44 yds, 2.4 wo). Brees and Payton remember their last trip here as in 2011 they were 5-2 and a 13' pt fav vs the 0-6 Rams and it was the only time other than LW at SEA the duo was held to under 300 yds (283, lost 33-23). We also have to point out NO is on a 3rd road game in 4 weeks, off a primetime SN game, off perhaps the 2 most physical D's in the league and travel for another Panther matchup next week. STL has held their own at home vs weaker foes beating CHI, JAX and ARZ but got mauled vs SF (outgained 370-188) while losing to SEA and TEN. The short week is something that hasn't affected Brees as he's 4-0 SU/ATS the week after covering by 8, 5, 21 and 5'.

Seattle by 13 over NY GIANTS - There may not be a bigger letdown spot this season than SEA. They are off an emotion packed Monday Night win vs a 9-2 Saints team, then travelled to face their only true rival and now traveling across country to play at 10am local time. That thought went out the window after a loss at SF as there were 7 lead changes with SF kicking a 22 yd FG w/26 left. SEA was 1-3 ATS as an AF is Wilson's rookie year and TY improved to 4-2 ATS having posted a 9-3-1 ATS record of a SU loss. NYG has been through an incredible stretch in their schedule and while they have gone 6-2 ATS the avg D they have faced is #27 with EVERY D ranking 18 or lower and still only avg'd 306 ypg on offense. SEA as we all know has the league's top D, has allowed one team to top 215 yds passing and are considering this a Super Bowl preview and certainly won't want to depart with a negative vibe of this stadium.

CLEVELAND by 3 over Chicago - This is a bad spot for the Bears off a long OT game vs MIN followed by a MNF home game vs DAL as this will be their 3rd road game in 4 Wks. Cutler's status will be strung out much of the week. LW CLE HC Chud said that the Browns are not jinxed, they were just not finishing which came to fruition again leading NE for 59 min before a ? PI pen gave them ANOTHER tough loss. It seems losing is contagious for the Browns as they've now dropped 7 of 8 and in their last 6 they've OUTGAINED ALL 6 foes with the leagues #6 D pulling the weight. In Chicago it's the new offense by HC Trestman that has pulled the weight. Not many coaches could take a QB (McCown) who totaled 61 passes the 3 previous years and have him complete 65% with a 7.9 ypa and 9-1 ratio. Bears are tough matchup with both Jeffrey (1109, 15.8) and Marshall (990, 12.7) now at 1000+ after Dallas but Cleveland is #5 in pass D. We will fade CH whose 2 road wins are at PIT where they got outgained 459-258 (+5 TO's) and at GB when Rodgers was KO'd after 2 pass att's.

INDIANAPOLIS by 7 over Houston - With the division basically clinched weeks ago the Colts have rotated wins and losses the last 6 games and that puts them at 8-0-1 ATS off a SU loss with Luck. Houston's owner wants Keenum and made his first big statement with a coaching change but his preferred QB has completed 53% his last 4 with a 2-4 ratio. Now the embattled Texans go into a loud, hostile environment in which they will celebrate clinching the division. Houston has to travel in B2B weeks for the first time TY. The home team was a perfect 6-0 ATS in this series but the Colts win in Houston (-1', 27-24) snapped that streak and now Indy looks for a 4th straight series cover at home and would like nothing better to kick a div foe when they're down and beat them for 12th straight time at home keeping them winless under the Horseshoe. Div AD's with 2 or less wins in December are 3-9-1 ATS as they look ahead to the offseason.

JACKSONVILLE by 4 over Buffalo - Since the bye the Jaguars have only won the yardage battle in one game (-135 ypg in rest) but are 4-1 SU/ATS with a direct result being HOU releasing their HC. Prior to the bye they were all g 161 ypg (4.9) on the ground, a 16-3 ratio (7.5 ypa) and earned just 11 sacks defensively. Since then its 71 ypg (2.9) rushing allowed, a 9-6 ratio with 12 sacks and a 6.9 ypa. This is the 3rd straight game away from Ralph Wilson Stadium for the Bills and they've lost 5 of 6 outright while the Jags have been the surprise of the league winning 4 of their last 5.

New England by 7 over MIAMI - If we wrote the road team is 3-3 SU but 1-5 ATS and the home team is 4-2 ATS but they had 13-6 and 16-6 HT leads in their 2 non-covers you would have bet this game is in New England. Earlier TY MIA went into NE and led 17-3 at HT and despite losing by 10 finished with a 309-252 yard edge. Miami is now hosting a meaningful home game for the first time in 4 years as they are tied with BAL for the final Wildcard spot but did lose to them earlier TY. Both teams are off wins but NE trailed the entire game and scored in the final minute as a 10 pt fav while MIA went into PIT as a dog and pulled the upset. The Patriots are always dangerous vs an upstart div foe wanting to prove they are still on top but while they are only 1-6 ATS on the road TY it has not been in this price range. Loss of Gronk will be big but Brady is back in form.

Philadelphia by 14 over MINNESOTA - Nick Foles with his 20-1 ratio takes on a MIN #30 pass def giving up 287 ypg (65%) with a 26-8 ratio. LY PHI gave up 48 sks (7.8%) with a respectable 117 ypg (4.5) on the ground (injuries & bad OL coaching). This year its up a bit with Foles 17 sks in 196 pass att's (8.7%) but they are avg 147 ypg (4.7) on the ground. PHI's still one of fastest offenses now on turf in a dome. MIN forced to be conservative on offense due to a bottom 5 QB situation (HOU, CLE, OAK, GB, JAX) wasting a decent set of receiving options & while they had potential with a healthy Peterson that may not be the case here. The emotionally drained Vikings are off B2B OT games and LW set a record with FIVE lead changes in the last 2:05 all g the Ravens to go 80 yds in :41 and score with :09 left. PHI rolls here.

Green Bay at Dallas - Aaron Rodgers' return is close to being too late but w/ LW's comeback win vs Atlanta keeps them in the hunt. One thing that can really heal a QB quickly is facing the league's worst defense which is all g 422 ypg. Let's remind everyone that when Rodgers was inj'd he was comp 67% with a 15-4 ratio and that included road games vs 3 top 10 D's (SF, CIN, BAL). The Cowboys were an automatic play against at home as into TY they were 3-17 ATS as a HF and while they did win and cover their first 3 in that role TY they have dropped the L/2. Dallas however still is an enigma as they were a 7 pt HD to Denver and outgained them but in their other 5 home games which they were a fav by an avg of 6 ppg they've been outgained by 40 ypg. We'll check on Rodgers and DAL off Monday Night.

Cincinnati at Pittsburgh (SNF) - Since Tomlin took over the Steelers in 2007 this is amazingly Pittsburgh's 16th AFC North game in prime time. Of those this is the eighth at home where Pittsburgh is only 4-3 SU and 2-5 ATS. Cincy knows this can be a season making win as a loss would tighten the screws with the Ravens just one behind holding the first win and a rematch coming in the season finale. When the Bengals are on the division road the dog is 13-6-1 ATS and would like nothing more in what they hope is a special season than to sweep the Steelers for only the second time S/99. A Bengals celebration or will the Steelers delight it?

Baltimore at Detroit (MNF) - This is the Ravens 6th road game and while they are only 1-5 SU/ATS the last 4 losses were by 15 total points. The Lions after their loss at PHI still leads the NFC North but the gap has closed. DET fans are ready to celebrate and this is their first primetime home game since Oct '11 but the Thanksgiving day crowd reminded us what Ford Field can be like which we expect here. Can the Ravens keep pace with Cincy or can Detroit lay claim to their first division title since Wayne Fontes was here in 1993?
