A look ahead to the 2014 NFL schedules. To the left we've provided to different rankings for each teams overall, home and away schedules for next season. They are ranked from easiest (#1) to hardest (#32) in each category. The ranking by Wins is based on the opponent's final 2013 record and we've given you the avg win's for each. Ex #1: Oakland plays the toughest overall schedule next year based their opponents records and each of their foes next season averaged an impressive 9.3 wins TY (avg record 9.3-6.7) Ex #2: Tennessee plays the easiest home schedule next year (based on opp's 2013 final records) as each of their foes averaged 6.5 wins TY (avg record 6.5-9.5).

The second ranking of comparing each teams strength of schedule based on each opponents average Power Rating (PR). Looking at the Overall schedule Tennessee plays the easiest schedule while St. Louis plays the toughest. New England has the largest discrepancy as they have the #23 schedule based on LY's win/loss records but have the #13 schedule based on their opponents final Power Ratings.

Below is each teams non-division home and road schedules. Each team of course plays all other division opponent both home and away. Each division has a quick comparison of all 4 teams, overall, home and away for both rankings, as well as how many top and bottom 10 offenses and defenses each team will face next season (based on '13's final numbers).

HANDICAPPING NOTES FOR THIS WEEK'S NFL SEMI-FINAL GAMES

Here are some notes for the Semi-Final round of the playoff games. We tried to put as much information as possible in the write-ups but there was not room for all of it. Below are some questions you might have about this upcoming round and our researched answers. Not all of these will be in effect for this week's games. If one is not, we are including it so you can add it to your handicapping arsenal.

How do double digit favorites do in the Semi-Final round? Remember, teams in the Semi-Final round not only have the home field edge but had a bye the previous week. They catch their opponent off a big win in the playoffs and playing a second straight tough game. Since the playoffs were expanded in 1990 there have been 20 DD favs and they've gone 12-8 ATS and 13-7 O/U. However, since 2002 there have been 5 DD favs and they are 3-2 SU and 2-3 ATS but did cover the L/2 incl NE in 2011 (-13', 45-10 vs Denver).

How does a road team do after a win in the Wild Card round? Since '97, this has happened 21 times. From '97-'02 there were 5 road teams which won (all underdogs) and they went 0-5 SU/ATS the next week. But since 2003 there have been 17 road teams which won in the WC round and while they were 8-9 SU in the Conf Semi's they did go 12-5 ATS. The 6 teams that won as AF's in the WC round are 6-1 ATS the next week incl Seattle covering last year.

How do teams do that COVER by double digits in the Wild Card round? Since the 4 game Wild Card round was started in 1990, there have been 42 teams that COVERED by double digits. Of those, 18 were underdogs in the WC round that pulled upsets and those teams went 6-12 ATS in the next round. Favorites that cruised to big wins are 10-13 ATS in the next round for an overall record of 16-25 ATS. No teams covered by DD LY and in 2011 the NY Giants won 24-2 (-3) and of course went on to win the Super Bowl.

How do upset winners in the Wild Card round that won SU by 13 points or more do in the next round? First of all, since 1981, teams that won SU as 6 pt dogs or more are just 2-8 ATS in the next round. Since the NFL went to the 4 game Wild Card round in 1990 there have been 11 teams that pulled an upset in the Wild Card round and won BIG (by 13 points or more). In the next round those teams are just 2-9 SU and 3-8 ATS with the last SU/ATS winner being CAR in 2005 when they also upset CHI in the Conf Semi-Finals. It hasn't occurred in the L3Y.

How have #1 seeds fared? Up until 2009 Vegas had overcompensated and the #1 seeds in the Conf Semis were 7-5 SU but 2-10 ATS. After the #1 seeds went 2-0 SU/ATS in '09 they've gone 2-4 SU & 1-5 ATS the L3Y. Before '09 when both #1 seeds went to the Super Bowl the last time a #1 seed won the SB was in 2003 as NE beat Carolina and the last time a #1 seed covered in the SB was in 2004 when Philadelphia was +7 and lost 24-21. The prior meeting of two #1 seeds was in 1993 as Dallas beat Buffalo 30-13.

How do teams do that are off an OT win? Since 1977, there have been 19 OT games in the NFL playoffs. In 2003 CAR and PHI were each off OT games when they played so we will toss out that result. Teams are just 4-12 SU off an OT win and 6-9-1 ATS as they are off an emotionally draining game and have had trouble the following week. LY Arizona beat GB but lost at NO but NO beat MIN in the Conf Finals and then beat IND for the SB. In '07 the Giants beat GB in the Conf Finals and then beat NE in the SB. In '06 Chicago beat Seattle in OT and then went on to win and cover against New Orleans. In 2003 TEN hung on for a win over PIT in OT and then were beaten by OAK 41-24 the next week while GB beat Seattle in OT and then should have beaten PHI (except for 4th and 34) but ended up losing in OT although they did cover (+5).

This is SEA's 1st home playoff game since they upset NO 41-36 in 2010 and while this is QB Wilson's 2nd year he has 2 games of playoff exp from LY. SEA is +96 ypg (+11 TO's) at home TY holding foes to 225 yds or less four times. SEA is also tops at +70 ypg (+8 TO's) vs teams that finished the year w/a winning record (4-3 SU/4-2-1 ATS). NO fell to SEA 34-7 on a soggy MNF event with the Seahawks dominating every phase. SEA posted a 429-188 yd edge, forced five 3 and outs and held Brees to under 200 yds in a full game for the 1st time since Nov 2009.

In a league defined by QB superstars it's hard to imagine that Brees gets overlooked. Only Peyton has been more consistent and only Brady has done more with less. Brees has tallied 5,000 yds passing 4 times in the L6Y and what makes it unique is that TE Graham is the only player with over 1,000 yds rec and only RB Thomas has over 400 yds rushing (549, 3.7). However, 4 players have over 70 rec's making it hard to scheme against HC Payton's spread the wealth system. NO's 37 sks allowed (#9) are the most since 2005 as the LT spot has been an issue TY and the WR's don't have quite the same speed as before. DC Ryan has done an excellent job taking LY's #32 def that allowed 440 ypg and improving it by 104 ypg finishing 4th. The fact that DE Jordan and OLB Gallette who had been a depth player prior to 2013 tallied 24.5 sks combined is very impressive. New Orleans' #2 pass defense has been dinged by injuries lately but after allowing a 31-15 ratio LY they only gave up a 20-12 ratio this year.

SEA made it clear that despite Wilson's excellent rookie season and the big names at WR that they would remain a run first team. They've run 55% of the time which was 2nd most TY. However, Wilson has shown he can compete in the passing game w/ a 101.2 QBR based on a good 8.2 ypa and solid 26-9 ratio. RB Lynch has tallied 29% of the Off w/ his 3rd straight 1,200+ yard rushing ssn. This has made it much easier on the #26 pass Off which has been minus its #1 (Rice) and #2 (Harvin) projected WR's most of the year. The Seahawks OL has weathered another year of inj's coming with LT Okung missing 8 gms with 12 of 44 sks (20th) esp in the L3 games. SEA's #1 D is built from the secondary forward w/ 3 All-Pro's and are 1 of 3 teams TY with more Int's (28) than TD's (16) with their 5.8 ypa allowed being #1. Six of the back 7 starters have at least 1 INT and 13 players have at least 1 sack TY and SEA is 3rd with 82 net TO pts. Aside from the OL sack rate the biggest concern with SEA is their #23 special teams as while they have given up just 82 yds on PR's they've allowed a 24.0 (20th) on KR's.

LW we cashed with the Saints UNDER as our 4★ here as they've now gone under in 6 straight on the road. NO was held to a season low 188 yds in their first meeting and while that experience will certainly benefit the offense here in knowing what to expect they still have avg'd just 16 ppg the L/5 away with 26 coming LW with the PHI's #29 D. SEA's DB's and run 1st policy w/ the 12 man call for the Under.

This is the 11th AFC East title for NE in the L13Y and NE is 7-2 SU/4-4-1 ATS w/Brady at the helm in the Division games had avg 283 ypg (63%) w/a 19-8 ratio in that round. Belichick's 18 caught a pass from him to start the year and he ended the playoff wins are just behind Tom Landry (20) and Don Shula (19) and NE has 31 players w/playoff experience. NE blasted IND 59-24 LY (9.5 pt HF) thanks to 2 INT/1 PR for TD's as the yardage was even. Fresh off the 2nd greatest postseason comeback, Luck now gets to play his 1st playoff road game (IND -9 ypg +6 TO's) vs NE who is +7 ypg (16th) at home but +7 TO's.

In the 1st 7 games w/WR Wayne IND avg 345 ypg/26.7 ppg but his injury and the loss of RB's Bradshaw/Ballard earlier shifted the entire offensive focus to Luck. RB Brown (537 yds 5.3) is the focal point of the ground game w/Richardson (458, 2.9) struggling to adapt. TY Hilton is the current #1 WR w/5 games of 100 yds rec. TE Fleener hasn't been very consistent w/drops/mistakes but is the #2 receiver by default w/Heyward-Bey dropping himself out of the offense. IND's #20 defense is very prone to the run (#26, 4.5, 11 gms of 115 ypg) but OLB Mathis' All-Pro level year (19.5 sks) shifts the balance a bit. Overall it's an average secondary led by CB Vontae Davis that has made the most of a weak division of QB's and a run oriented NFC West TY. IND has our #24 special teams for 2013 as their coverage units have been awful (#31 PR/#27 KR).

Other QB's may have better stats in 2013 but no QB has succeeded w/less than Brady TY. Only Edelman had caught a pass from him to start the year and he ended the year w/a 1,000 yd season. Five other Patriots have 30 or more rec's but despite not having a 1,000 yd rusher they are 6th in rushing the 2H of the year w/138 ypg (4.6). NE's adoption of NO's "spread the wealth" style of play in 2012 (5 w/40 or more rec's) eased the burden TY. NE's 40 sks allowed TY may be 11th best its the most given up since 2008 but their 4.4 ypc in #9. Statistically NE's #25 D (#30 vs the run) is a glaring issue due to injuries but they are 9th in pts allowed (21.1) due to situational football, a pass def allowing 57% w/a 7.0 ypa and 24 sks the L8W. Led by Chandler Jones 11.5 sks, 15 players have at least 1 as NE brings in different alignments. Even with NE's lack of depth/exp issues they have the 2nd best special teams unit for a playoff team TY coming in #6.

IND hung a 19-10 FD and 369-163 yd edge on KC after each teams opening drive of the 2H as the Chiefs lost 4 starters (3 off) in the game. Teams that score 40+ are 3-13 ATS in the next game and those that put up 500+ yds are 1-4-1 ATS. No one takes away a foes strengths (IND TY like Belichick or plays to his own (#9 rush off 4.4 vs IND #26 4.5). IND had a full season worth of breaks go their way w/ KC but don't expect that to be the case vs a Brady led team with a big edge in the ground game here.

This is the Panthers' 1st playoff gm in 5 yrs and while the NFL is smitten with the pass 1st philosophy, CAR has a distinct old school style to them. Operating under a 50/50 run pass mix, Newton's size/athletic mix gives OC Shula a great deal of flexibility as moves like a RB but throws like a franchise QB. CAR is +33 ypg (+9 TO's) at home TY and are tops in pts allowed at home (12.0) and #2 with 31 sks. CAR earned their 1st statement win of 2013 with a 10-9 effort (+6) over SF. CAR held SF to 10 FD/151 yds forcing five 3 and outs as SF didn't have Crabtree and Vernon Davis (concussion) only had 22 snaps. San Francisco has a massive edge in playoff experience vs Carolina with 6 games since 2011.

SF started off '13 w/an identity issue as they tried to be a pass oriented tm despite their receiving woes and lost 2 of 3 to start. They went back to their run first/crushing D style after losing to IND avg 146 ypg (4.4) since, holding foes to 85 ypg (3.8) rush. SF also forced Kaepernick to stay in the pocket more early on as opposing D's keyed in on option style QB's w/big hits. SF has let him use his legs more lately and WR Boldin (85 rec 13.9) has been worth his weight in gold as the #1 receiver with 36.7% of the rec yds. TY. TE Davis has been reliable again as the safety outlet and while the 49ers OL isn't quite as stout as LY's they remain a top 10 unit. SF's #5 D is also not quite as good as '12 due to susp's (LB Smith) and injuries (just six 16 gm st's) but they still have arguably the best LB unit in the NFL w/Bowman and Willis with Smith now focused on the field and they are the only tm to not allow a 100 yard rusher this year.

CAR's #26 Off is the lowest of the 12 playoff teams and they are the only playoff team w/o a 1,000 yd rusher or receiver TY. Part of this is their #2 D and #11 special teams helping them start 13% of their drives on the other side of the field. On the surface Newton's 88.8 QBR is good but not great but if you add his rushing stats into the formula (111-585-6 td) it bumps to 95.7. RB Williams is more than capable of carrying the rushing load the system simply doesn't call for it. Newton still takes a good deal of sacks (43 #18) but at 6-5 245 he's bigger than all 3 of the Panthers starting LB's so he can absorb them. CAR also spreads the ball around in the passing game with 4 players having over 35 rec's and while TE Olsen leads the team in rec's and yds the Panthers 44% on 3rd downs is #4. CAR's 3rd down D is 12th thanks to their stellar front 7 that is playing like the 2002 Bucs with 40 of their 60 sks coming from the DL. Combined with All-Pro LB Kuechly CAR has forced 11 games under 100 yds rushing avg 68 ypg (3.5) vs 129 (4.6) in the others.

San Fran is in a rough spot as they got a tougher than expected effort from ATL on Monday Night Football, got a physical game at ARZ, are off a brutally cold game vs GB and now have to come East. We'll take the Panthers due to physical nature with rest as SF has already lost as a road dog to a pair of teams (Sea & NO) with top 5 defenses. Cannot emphasize how much confidence Panthers got from midseason wins vs SF and NE in back-to-back weeks.

The Broncos #1 Off puts tons of stress whether they line up in 3 WR's with Welker as the slot or 2 TE's with Julius Thomas being the Joker TE in passing routes and Tammie being the blocker. Part of DEN's NFL low 20

skis is Manning and he's enjoyed the same 5 OL starters for 13 games. In the 1H of the year DEN gave up 381 ypg/27.3 ppg but as they adjusted in the 2H of the year they trimmed to 331 ypg/22.6 ppg which is 11th in yds & 17th in ppg. This is despite only DT Knighton/WLB Treva-

pass game to reduce the deep balls and put more focus on than being the only ones to start all 16 games. If Manning is slowed the Broncos are vulnerable vs the run w/8 games of 110+ yds (141 ypg, 4.4). DEN is +40 ypg (-6 TO's) vs foes w/a winning record TY (4-3 SU/ATS) and own the #26 special teams for 2013.

Mike McCoy knows the in and out of the DEN offense having been the OC there from 2010-12 before taking over at SD. Playoff AD's that won SU as AD's are 11-4 ATS inc SB's and DD AD's are a respectable 15-13 ATS TY. While DEN's defense isn't quite as robust as LY's especially minus Von Miller the status of Ryan Mathews (ankle) is uncertain at best. Manning is avg 352 ypg (69%) w/a 27-5 ratio at home TY and the early weather forecast has it in the low 40's. These 2 teams finished as the #1 and #6 off over their last 8 games, Manning was held to a ssn low with 10 or more TD's and 1 of two teams (CHI) with a 1,000 in last mtg and DEN put up 35 LY in the playoffs and lost.
