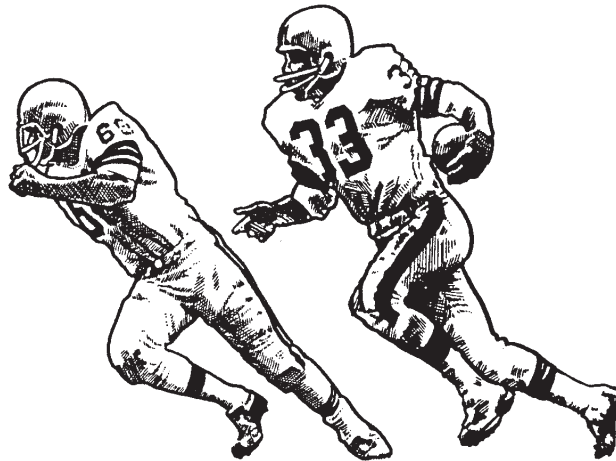

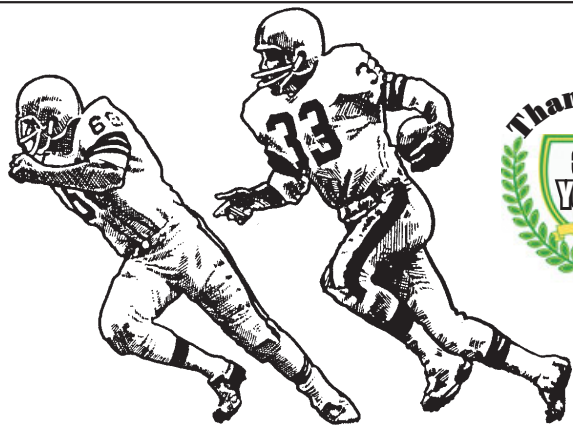

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Louisville over BOSTON COLLEGE - 7th overall meeting, tied 3-3. BC lost the L/gm ('98), 52-28 (-6). Both tms come in 6-3. Louisville is +102 ypg vs the #54 sked while BC is +94 ypg vs the #72 sked. BC QB Tyler Murphy despite being a mediocre passer, could be the best running QB in the country as he leads all QB's in the FBS with 965 yds (7.4!) and 9 td's. LW BC got a 38-10, 57-yd TD run by Murphy late in the 4Q that keyed a 33-31 upset (+3) over VT. The gm was a bit misleading as the Hokies had a 414-368 yd edge. L'Ville led defending Nat'l Champ FSU 21-0 (could have been worse but SOD at the 1). However, FSU recovered their own fumble in the EZ for a td and that sparked them as the Cards were outscored 42-10 down the stretch and gave up 574 yds (were #1 D in country). One bright spot for them is that they are a completely diff offense w/Gardner, Dyer and Parker all healthy. They have the D to stop a one dimensional BC offense that can't throw the ball and will play inspired knowing they let one get away from them LW, while the D will also play with a chip on their shoulders after all'g so many pts and yds.

FORECAST: Louisville by 13

3★ FRESNO ST over San Jose St - 78th meeting. In '90 SJSt won 42-7 then FSU went 16-1 SU/9-6-1 ATS. SJSt has now pulled outright upsets each of the last 2 years. FSU hasn't dropped 3 str s/79-'81. LTH ('11) FSU was -6' and led 17-10 at HT but the Spartans won 27-24. LY FSU was playing with BCS pressure. Carr hit 38-50-519 & Fales 37-45-547 and in the 1H the two teams comb'd for 1,016 yds and 45 FD. FSU trailed 42-41 (most pts at HT between 2 tms in MW history). SJSt opened the 2H w/an inside & drove for a td, 49-41 and increased it to 62-44 w/4:46 left. FSU is off a 45-17 (-11') upset loss vs Wyoming, who had a ssn high 694 ttl yds. SJSt is off a 38-31 (+7) loss vs CSU. The Spartans rec'd an inside kick w/2:19 left but were SOD at their own 41. The HT is on a 7-3-1 ATS run & FSU is 10-6 under DeRuyter as a HF incl 2-1 TY. SJSt was on a 6-1 run as an AD but is 0-3 in that role TY (avg loss by 24 ppg). FSU had a bye 2 wks ago, has a bye on deck while SJSt is on their 3rd AG in 4 wks. This is a team off an embarrassing loss, playing w/legit revenge and LW this line would have been at least 7.

FORECAST: FRESNO ST by 7

3★ TULSA over Smu - In the L/gm ('12) UT lost 35-27 (-5). UT had clinched the CUSA West (title gm on deck) and trailed 35-6 w/4:14 3Q. After a td w/5:05 left UT cut it to 8 then punted next drive. On the final pl from SMU35 they were stopped at the SMU11 Battle of the AAC basement here as SMU is the only winless tm left in the country at 0-7 (1-6 ATS). They do come in off a bye after their 48-10 loss to Memphis (+23). On the other side, Tulsa has lost 7 str gms after their ssn opener. They have been more competitive than the Ponies as LW we cashed a Fri Night Marquee on them in their 40-20 loss (+24') to Memphis. Scores before the half are big and Memphis got a 51 yd TD run w/14 left in the 1H to take the lead 20-14. Tulsa was only outgained 426-411 while SMU was outgained 582-241 to Memphis. Despite their records, these 2 tms are not that similar as Tulsa in AAC play is actually outgaining their foes by 20 ypg while SMU is -251 ypg. We're not afraid to lay it and play it here on the home tm as this could be their L/chance for a win (UCF, Hou, EC on deck).

FORECAST: TULSA by 17

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ TCU over Kansas St - Defacto B12 Champ gm with playoff implications. Gary Patterson is a KSU grad but is 0-2 SU/1-1 ATS vs his alma mater. LTH ('11) KSU was -3 and the Wildcats led 23-0 4Q & won 23-10. LY KSU was -11' and was up 17-7 at HT. TCU went up 31-30 but KSU hit a GW 41 yd fg w/0:3 left. There were 7 lead changes (3 in the 4Q). We upgraded our 2★ selection on these pages LW to a 4★ LPS on Saturday & easily cashed as KSU shut down OSU 48-14 (-13). The Wildcats were up 28-7 early 3Q & held the Pokes to just 48 yds in the 2H. TCU hit a 37 yd fg w/no time left to sneak past WV 31-30 (-5). Snyder is in a favorable role as he is 13-1 as an AD with 7 outright upsets, but TCU is 7-1 ATS TY incl 4-0 as a HF, covering by an avg of 16 ppg. Against 3 common foes (TT, OU, OSU) TCU is 3-0 SU/ATS, +31 ppg & +255 ypg while KSU is 3-0 SU/ATS, +22 ppg & +67 ypg. We have cashed 5 2★ selections on these pages on the Horned Frogs and off their first non-cover of the ssn, we're not afraid to back them again here and we grab extra value considering TCU's blown lead vs Baylor a few wks back and KSt's misleading win at Oklahoma.

FORECAST: TCU by 10

2★ Ulm over APPALACHIAN ST - First meeting. LW the Warhawks nearly pulled off the upset of the yr as despite being a 5 td dog, they only lost 21-16 to Texas A&M. It wasn't a fluke as they had a 347-243 yd edge but settled for 2 short FG's in the 2H. We easily cashed our TV Total on the ULM/A&M gm to go UNDER (TV side and TV total a perfect 7-0 the L/3 wks and can be purchased for just \$9 on your VIP Debit system on Saturdays). App St is off a 44-0 (-13) blowout win over Ga St as the gm was played in light snow. The Mountaineers dominated with 26-6 FD and 567-62 yd edges. They have now destroyed the two weakest tms in the SBC the L/2 wks and this gives us some line value as LY ULM won at Troy, at ULL and at Texas St and should have beaten Texas St 2 wks ago (led 18-7 mid 4Q) while almost upsetting an SEC tm LW. Their backs are clearly against the wall here and they have the huge D edge (#65-110).

FORECAST: Ulm by 3

OTHER GAMES

Wednesday, November 5th

Buffalo at OHIO - The Bulls are now 4-3 SU/5-2 ATS the L/7 in the series. The home team is an outstanding 12-3 SU in this series (9-6 ATS) and there have been 4 outright upsets the L7Y. LY was a close game late in the 2Q, but BU dominated after that finishing with a 421-233 yd edge incl 252-69 on the ground in their 30-3 win (-3'). This is just the 2nd gm s/Oct 11 for UB as they are 3-5 SU/ATS and have an interim coach. OU is 4-5 SU/3-6 ATS and has a bye on deck. A loss here would pretty much end their tm's bowl hopes.

Northern Illinois at BALL ST - NIU has won the L/5 SU (3-2 ATS) and the visitor is 4-1 ATS and has won 7 of the L/11 SU. LY NI was -7 at home in a winner take all MAC West showdown. The game was a lot closer than the 48-27 final as BSt led 24-20 at half and with 8:23 left the game was tied at 27 before the Huskies scored the final 21 pts. Huskies are 6-2 TY but have failed to cover 5 str gms while Ball St started off slow, but has pulled B2B upsets. Do the Huskies get back on track or does BSt continue to ride their momentum?

Thursday, November 6th

Clemson at WAKE FOREST - Both are fresh off a bye. CU has won 5 in a row SU (by 27 ppg) and is 4-1 ATS. LY CU was -28 at home and finished with a 573-222 yd edge leading 35-7 at the half and cruised 56-7. The Tigers come in at 6-2 and have won 5 str gms. However, w/Stoudt

at QB they have failed to cover each of their L/3 gms. WF is 2-6 SU/4-4 ATS and their offense has been atrocious avg just 35 rush ypg (1.1, 32 sks). That's not good news facing a Clem D that has 28 sks. However, WF's D has been respectable all'g just 25 ppg, while Clem's offense is avg 19 ppg L/3 gms.

Friday, November 7th

Memphis at TEMPLE - LY TU was winless in AAC play coming into the gm but dominated the Tigers on the road with a 534-228 yd edge in their 41-21 (+8) upset. TY both tms are much improved and a win here by either tm would make them bowl elig. LW we cashed a Fri Night Marquee going against Mem in their 40-20 win (-24') over Tulsa. We also had another outright upset winner for our Big Dog plays as Temple beat E Car 20-10 (+10). Did you get your Big Dog plays this week? (Available for just \$9 on your VIP Debit system on Wednesdays). Who remains in the race for the AAC title?

Utah St at WYOMING - Utah St has won each of the L/2 meetings SU/ATS by an avg of 49-13. LY the Cowboys trailed 35-0 after 3Q's gaining 37% (70) of their yds in the 4Q. Eight of their 1st 11 drives went 8 yds or less. Both tms have been hit hard by the inj bug TY, but it didn't matter LW as Utah St beat Hawaii 35-14 (-3) while WY upset Fresno 45-17 (+14'). Technical edges to Utah St here as they are 6-2 ATS as an AF while WY is 4-9-1 ATS as a HD. However, situational edge to WY as Utah St got back late from a road trip to the Islands and on a short week travelling again.

Saturday, November 8th

Penn St by 3 over INDIANA - IU had never beaten PSU (0-16) but got that monkey off their back LY in a big way. PSU got within 21-17 but IU rolled to a 44-24 win (+3'). TY the Hoosiers get to host PSU for a 2nd str yr. It's tough to back either team here as both come in on 3 gm losing streaks. IU is on a 3-12 ATS run vs the B10 and LW lost to Mich 34-10 (+7). They clearly are not the same tm w/out their QB's (Sudfeld OFY, Roberson trans prior) as Zander Diamont (only 11 pass yds vs Mich St) attempted only 8 passes LW despite being down most of the gm. Speaking of struggling QB's, a case could be made that no QB has regressed more than PS's Hackenberg who has a 7-10 ratio TY (20-10 LY) and LW was just 18-42-177-1-1 in their 20-19 loss (-3') to MD as we cashed our NC Sports Comp Underdog POW on MD (given out FREE every Tuesday on button #3 by calling 1-347-677-1700). Penn St does have a huge edge on D (#8-109), but Indy RB Coleman does have 8 consecutive gms w/at least 100 rush yds and it's tough laying over a FG here w/a Penn St offense avg 15 ppg in B10 play TY.

Georgia by 14 over KENTUCKY - UGA is off UF with Aub on deck. However, LY they were off Aub and had GT on deck, but still drilled the Wildcats 59-17 (-26) despite losing QB Murray late in the 1H. UGA is on a 22-3 SU run in the series but UK is 5-3 ATS incl 3-1 ATS here at home. According to the Westgate LV SuperBook, Georgia entered LW as the co-favorite to win the Nat'l Champ at 5-1 (along w/FSU & Bama) but their Nat'l Champ hopes took a severe and possibly fatal blow as they were completely run over in a 38-20 (-10') loss to UF all'g 418 rush yds. On the other side, UK is much improved TY but is off 3 str losses and have road trips to Tenn/L'Ville remaining on their sked. LW they fell to Mizzou 20-10 (+8) as we easily cashed a 3★ College Totals LPS on the UNDER. KY needs a win for bowl elig. UGA needs to get the bad taste out of their mouths from LW.

Louisiana Tech by 4 over UAB - Blazers are 0-4 SU/1-2 ATS vs the Bulldogs (all gms after '96). In the L/meeting ('99) UAB lost 41-20 (+8). Both tms are among the most improved tms in the country TY. LW we easily cashed a 4★ Key Selection on these pages on LT as they hammered WKU 59-10 (-7) covering by six touchdowns! They had 31-15 FD and 507-297 yd edges. On the other side, UAB is off a somewhat misleading gm vs FAU as they led the Owls 28-7 in the 4Q (held FAU to 46 1H yds). However, they all'd 3 TD's before kicking a 24-yd FG w/0:2 left for the win. UAB had a 423-322 yd edge and QB Cody Clements after missing the Ark gm due to inj, did play but was just 16-26-184-1-0. Holtz is 3-0 ATS here as an AF and LT is 10-4 as an AF s/07 while UAB is off 3 str AG's and is 8-3 as a HD. We'll back the road team here who has the much better D (#39-97) but lost most of our value considering their 49 pt win LW.

Iowa by 6 over MINNESOTA - UM is fresh off a bye while Iowa had a bye 2 wks ago and NW LW. This is the 2nd str yr UM has hosted. LY while UM was 4-0 and Iowa 3-1, the Hawkeyes were +135 ypg vs a tougher schedule and UM was +15 ypg vs a weaker schedule. This was our NC Sports Comp College POW and Iowa dominated winning 23-7 (-2'). In the L/2 yrs Iowa has outscored UM 41-0 in the 1H. TY much of the same could be said for both tms. Minnesota was a fake team at 6-1 (-16 ypg) and we won outright w/our Underdog POW on these pages in their 28-24 loss (-4) to Illinois. Now they play the best the Big 10 has to offer w/Ohio St, Neb and Wisc on deck. On the other side, Iowa is off a 48-7 (-4) blowout win over NW as they had a 483-180 yd edge and got their 1st 100-yd rusher in 11 gms (surprising). Iowa has covered 8 of their L/9 gms away from Kinnick stadium and they usually travel well here.

NORTHWESTERN by 3 over Michigan - UM is 11-2 SU s/'97 but NW is 7-6 ATS. LY was a tough loss for NW as they dropped at least 4 sure fire int's, but still had the game won. With no time-outs UM rushed their FG unit on the field and their K never stopped moving (should have been illegal procedure), but they got a 44 yd fg to send it to OT and won it in 3OT, 27-19 (+3). The visitor is 6-1 ATS. Instead of worrying about being unionized, the NW players should have spent more time trying to improve on the field TY (have been hurt by inj/susp) as they are currently on a 4-12 SU and 3-15 ATS run! LW they were embarrassed 48-7 (+4) at Iowa. On the other side, Mich and Brady Hoke got a much-needed 34-10 win (-7) over Indy as they had 20-10 FD and 404-191 yd edges. Tough to back either tm here as UM is 2-7 ATS on the road and the loser can pretty much kiss their bowl hopes goodbye.

Georgia Tech by 6 over NC STATE - The visitor has won 5 str by 10 ppg (4-0-1 ATS). The last time GT lost in Raleigh was in '00 and s/'96 they are 6-1 (5-1-1) traveling here incl a 45-35 win (-10) the LTH ('11). Both tms come in riding high off conf wins. NC State got their 1st ACC win under Doeren (had lost 12 str) as they beat Syracuse 24-17 (+3'). The final was misleading as they were outFD'd 20-14 and benefitted from a +3 TO margin which incl an 82-yd IR td. GT, meanwhile, is off B2B blowout wins as LW they beat UVA 35-10 (-4). They are playing their 6th str gm here while NCSSt just had a bye 2 wks ago. GT HC Johnson is 9-4-1 as an AF here but NCSSt counters w/a 12-6-1 ATS mark as a HD. GT is +10 ppg in ACC play (+54 ypg) while NCSSt is -16 ppg (-120 ypg). We'll back the visitor, once again here.

Wisconsin by 17 over PURDUE - Purdue has the situation edge here as UW is on their 2nd str road game and has Neb on deck while PU has a bye on deck. However, the Badgers have owned the series as they have won 8 in a row SU/ATS in this series. They have won the L/4 matchups by 32 ppg and in the L3Y, UW has had a 360 ypg advantage winning their last 3 trips to PU by 24, 21 and 21. LY PU was off their big effort vs ND, UW was off a loss and we used UW as a 3★ on these pages and they won 41-10 (-22'). The Badgers are now rolling after B2B dominating wins. LW they destroyed Rutgers 37-0 (-12') as they had a 385-139 yd edge. For the ssn, they are +223 ypg (#5 in the country). On the other side, Purdue lost to Neb 35-14 (+23') but we still cashed a 2★ on these pages on the Boilers (2★'s are 15-5 75% this yr!). They have now covered 4 str and are 7-2 ATS on the yr but are 3-7 ATS as a HD and 1-10 SU/3-8 ATS hosting B10 foes. They were outgained by 264 and 192 yds in 2 td losses to Iowa and Mich St at home earlier TY and we'll call for the Badgers to roll over them for a 9th straight time.

Duke by 3 over SYRACUSE - Syracuse is 0-2 including a 33-6 loss in the last meeting, but that was in 1939. While Duke is on B2B road, they just had a bye 2 wks ago while the Orange are playing a 9th straight wk. While they are 7-1 and outscoring their foes by 17 ppg, the Blue Devils are getting outgained on the ssn! In conf play they are -140 ypg despite their 3-1 mark. LW was no different as they were outgained 594-438 (incl 358-172 rush), but got a 100-yd KR td and then watched Pitt's K who is appropriately named Blewitt as he literally "blew it" for Panther backers by missing a chipshot 26-yd FG that would have won the gm in regulation. Duke came away w/a 51-48 2OT win (+3). On the other side, Syracuse had a misleading 24-17 loss (-3) to NCSt LW as they had a 345-307 yd edge but were -3 in TO's incl an 82-yd IR td. While there is definitely some value on the Orange here (+19 ypg despite their 3-6 record) and the Blue Devils continue to play with fire, it's tough going against a team that has won 15 of their L/16 gms in the reg ssn.

Florida by 14 over VANDERBILT - UF is playing with legitimate revenge. LY the Gators had a 22 gm win streak in this series and VU got their first win in Gainesville s/45 which was the first of 46 meetings between the schools. While VU won 34-17, they had td drives of 10, 22 and 4 yds. The situation favors VU as they only had ODU LW with a bye on deck while UF is off their big win vs UGA with SC on deck. LW UF had 418 rush yds (most g/89). QB Harris was just 3-6-27 in his 1st start in a gm played in 40 mph wind gusts however, UF had 2 rushers top 190 yds. Georgia had a 460-445 yd edge but UF led 31-7 at one pt in the 38-20 win (+10'). On the other side, Vandy also played their best game of the ssn as they beat ODU 42-28 (-7'). They had 33-16 FD and 524-336 yd edges. The Gators are playing with revenge, are underrated and could be recharged for a late ssn run w/a new QB. 2 wks ago, we loved them in this one, but we certainly lost a little bit of value with that dominating win LW.

KANSAS by 1 over Iowa St - KU had won 5 in a row SU in this series from '05-'09 but ISU has now won 4 in row (by 19 ppg) and they are 4-0 ATS. The home team is 13-4 SU in this series but after HT got 11-2-1 ATS they are just 1-4 ATS the last 5. LY was the coldest game in Jack Trice Stadium and ISU, ply their FHG had a 502-279 yd edge in their 34-0 win (-4'). KU had just come off an upset win over WV and were still celebrating their first B12 win in 26 games. ISU is off a physical game vs Okla but had a bye prior to that and a bye next wk. Both tms were destroyed by the B12's best LW as ISU lost to OU 59-14 (+15) getting outFD'd 41-17 and outgained 751-334. KU, meanwhile lost to Baylor 60-14 (+35') getting outFD'd 30-12 and outgained 669-304. One of the best handicapping systems that we like to play-on is taking defensive home dogs (KU #64-105 D edge) and when you add in the fact the Cyclones are a rare B12 AF (1-3 ATS s/04), we'll back the home dog in this one.

ARKANSAS ST by 4 over South Alabama - LY was one of 4 gms, the Jaguars lost by a combined total of FIVE points. SA was held to fg's from the ASU 2, 10 and 13 and they fell 17-16 (-3'). LTH Ark St won 36-29 (-21). Ark St comes in off a 44-28 win (-17') over Idaho as remarkably they failed to cover despite having a 8-1 TO advantage! Idaho led 28-24 at one pt. LW we cashed a 3★ LPS against SA in their 19-9 loss (+7) to ULL. They did lead the gm 9-3 at one pt and had a fumb! at the ULL 2, which ULL then drove 91 yds for a td that sealed the gm. Prior to the gm, SA had beaten the 4 weakest tms in the SBC which gave us some value. Both tms have been good in this role as ASU is 3-0 ATS TY as a HF (15-7 ATS run) and this is their 1st HG in over a month. On the other side, SA is 9-5 ATS as an AD. Both tms are chasing ULL and Ga Southern in the SBC and the loser will most likely be eliminated. Ark St has played the tougher sked and is +79 ypg while USA is +24. Ark St stays in the SBC race.

HOUSTON by 20 over Tulane - UH has won 10 str in the series (9-1 ATS) dropping 40+ pts L/5. In the L/gm ('12, UH's last as a CUSA member) the Cougars won 40-17 (-12). UH had a 202 yd edge & after a 17-0 lead w/3:39 1Q maintained a DD advantage the entire gm. The Cougars come in on a roll as they have won and covered each of the 3 gms QB Ward has st'd. LW they beat USF 27-3 (-7') on the road. Their D is all'g just 14 ppg in CUSA play and that is not good news for a Tulane offense that is avg just 12 ppg in their L/5 gms and LW we cashed a Fri Night Marquee on the UNDER in their 38-14 (+4') loss to Cincy. QB Lee ret'd from inj & hit 24-35-205 but they were down 24-0 at HT. The Cougars are on a 11-3 ATS run in conf gms, have owned the series and we'll call for them to do it again here.

TROY by 6 over Georgia St - Battle of two of the worst tms in CFB. First meeting was LY and Troy failed to cover as a 16 pt away fav in their 35-28 win. Troy ran 102 plays, which was their most s/08 and they also totaled 634 yds (ssn high). The Trojans trailed 28-21 in the 4Q but went 63/2pl w/a GW 54 yd td pass w/3:17 left. 1-8 Troy is off a 42-10 loss (+25') to Ga Southern as they were held to 13 yds passing, which is unheard of for the Trojans considering they have always been known as a high-powered offense and just graduated the SBC's all-time leading passer. On the other side, 1-8 Ga St fared even worse in their 44-0 loss (+13) to App St as they were outFD'd 26-6 and outgained 567-62. The gm was played in light snow. Tough to back either tm here but the technical edges do favor the Panthers as they are on an 8-2 ATS run as an AD while Troy is 5-15 ATS as a HF and has been outright upset 2x in that role TY.

RICE by 10 over Utsa - In '12 Rice was only -2' at home and rolled to a 34-14 win with a 483-238 yd edge. HC Bailiff was a HS football player in San Antonio in the '70s. LY Rice was at SA (E). Rice led 6-0 & 20-7 at HT w/a 237-199 yd edge. After taking a 27-7 lead into the 4Q Rice all'd 78 & 76 yd td drives. Up only 6, the Owls rec the onside w/1:24 left to seal the win. SA is fresh off a bye while Rice is playing a 3rd str wk. These two tms come in on complete opposite ends of the spectrum as the Owls after a slow start (0-3), have now won and covered 5 str gms after their 31-17 win over FIU LW. On the other side, UTSA has been one of TY's biggest disappointments as after starting off the yr 1-1 SU/2-0 ATS that incl a 20 pt win at Houston and a near upset over Ariz, they have gone 1-5 SU/ATS since and in their L/gm was embarrassed at home to UTEP 34-0 (+13) as they were outgained 351-70. Rice is 13-5 ATS as a HF and this is HC.

OLD DOMINION by 6 over Uiu - First meeting. FIU was a fake tm early in the yr that benefitted from huge TO margins in wins over UAB and FAU. They have now lost 3 str gms and LW fell to Rice at home 31-17 (+7). While ODU has failed to cover 5 str gms incl LW to Vandy 42-28 (+7') (they deserved so much better vs WKU 2 wks ago), they are back at home after 3 str AG's. They have the much better offense here that can put yds and pts up on anyone and we'll call for them to get back on track here as a loss by either tm eliminates them from bowl contention.

West Virginia by 3 over TEXAS - WV has given Texas a handful the L2Y. In their first meeting, WV was +7 at UT and escaped with a 48-45 win in '12. LY UT was -5 on the road. They trailed 26-16 mid-3Q but down 3 went 57/12pl for a gm tying fg w/13 left. UT got a td & int'd WV (from UT4) in OT and won 47-40. LW WV had a 27-14 lead mid-3Q but got just 1 FD after that and lost 31-30 (+3') as TCU got a 37-yd FG on the final play. On the other side, Texas was facing a bkp QB and then a walk-on QB after an inj as they had a 469-381 yd edge in their 34-13 win (-4') over TT. They are in must win mode here at 4-5 and Charlie Strong would like nothing better than getting his young tm 15 extra bowl pract. West Virginia did win its two B12 road games earlier TY but they barely beat TT and the Okla St win was much closer than the final. How much do they have left in the tank after LW's gm?

Ucla by 1 over WASHINGTON - The HT is 10-3 SU/7-5-1 ATS the last 13 and UCLA is 9-2 SU/7-4 ATS s/01. UCLA HC Jim Mora played and was a grad asst at UW. LY UW had not beaten UCLA at the Rose Bowl s/95 and trailed 27-7 in a Friday night game. UW got a td w/8:01 left,

41-31. UW QB Price was inj'd and Miles QB'd the 2H. LW Colorado was up 23-17 but fumbled and Wash went 46/5pl for a TD. UW then got a 30 yd IR TD and an 87 yd PR TD to win by 15 as we washed a 3★ LPS College Totals on the OVER. LW UCLA QB Hundley had 131 yds rush and after falling behind 7-0 early, the Bruins controlled matters in a 17-7 win (-7) as they had a 460-255 yd edge. It was just their 2nd cover of the ssn despite their 7-2 SU record. UW is 5-2 as a HD, 1-1 TY under Petersen which is rare because never was a HD at Boise. Tough backing a UCLA tm that has been underwhelming so far TY outside of gms against the Arizona schools and are playing their 3rd AG in 4 wks.

† Connecticut by 3 over Army - Army is 1-4 (-1 only win in 1979). In the L/gm ('06) Army only trailed 14-17 in the 4Q, but lost by 14 (all'd 72 yd PR). This gm will be played at Yankee Stadium, Army is 0-2 SU/ATS here incl a 27-12 loss (+9) in '11 vs Rutgers while Conn has never played here. It's not often that we back one of the worst tms in a conf over one of the best tms in a conf, but LW we washed a 3★ LPS on the Huskies as they pulled the outright upset over UCF 37-29 (+9). UCF was yet another warm weather Florida tm experiencing the cold, wind and rain and their QB threw 4 ints. That is now B2B covers for the Huskies who were 0-6 ATS to start the ssn. On the other side, Army has disappointed us yet again TY as they are on a 1-6 SU/ATS run and LW fell to rival AF 23-6 (+3) as they were outgained 383-169. Both tms are bad on the road tms as Uconn is 1-7 SU/2-6 ATS away from Storrs while Army is even worse 0-9 SU/ATS away from Michie Stadium w/an avg loss by 17 ppg, avg line -4. They have actually lost 19 str road gms dating back to 2010. Will UConn be caught celebrating LW's win or will it give them confidence?

AUBURN by 21 over Texas A&M - Slight situational edge to A&M here who had a bye 2 wks ago and only ULM LW so they will be poised for revenge and fresh. Meanwhile Auburn is in a Ole Miss/UGA sandwich and also went to the wire vs S Car 2 wks ago. LTH A&M's OC McKinley said once the game began, it felt like we just ran up and down the field on them and A&M won 63-21 (-14'). LY's game was a shootout with Aub having a 615-602 yd edge. A&M took the lead 41-38 w/5:05 left but Aub got a td with 1:19 left and ran the ball 22x for 168 yds in the 4Q. We don't know what is worse, losing 59-0 to Alabama or after a bye week to get fresh and get that bad taste out of your mouth, the Aggies nearly lost to 5 td underdog ULM LW barely escaping 21-16 (-34'). They were outgained 347-243 and Kyle Allen was just 13-28-106 in his 1st start. On the other side, the Tigers were fortunate to come away from Ole Miss w/a 35-31 win (+1') as Ole Miss had the go-ahead TD with 1:31 left but lost WR Treadwell to a broken leg and the play was overturned. Clearly the Tigers are the better tm but their D has all'd 35 ppg and 499 ypg the L/3 wks and this is a sandwich gm.

Alabama by 6 over LSU - Bama is 3-1 SU (2-2 ATS). When Bama travelled here in '12, they trailed most of the game and were fortunate to pull out a 21-17 win (-8'). LY they were -11 at home and Saban won his 3rd straight vs Miles. Our Power Plays newsletter had a forecasted score of 38-17 for the game and was right on the money (2014 PS subs can get an email version of PP for the rest of the ssn for just \$35!). However, the game was closer than the final. At the half LSU had a 232-193 yd edge but trailed 17-14 and it was tied at 17 early 3Q. Both Bama and LSU come in off a bye and both are playing their best ball of the ssn. The Crimson Tide are +232 ypg on the ssn vs the #12 sked while LSU is +96 ypg vs the #29 sked. Technical edges to LSU here as Bama is 0-3 TY as an AF (incl beat outright) and 1-6 in that role the L2Y. LSU is 1-0 TY as a HD (outright upset) & 3-0 in that role s/10 incl 2 covers over Bama & one outright. Both tms have Top 5 D's and while both tms prefer to run the ball, the diff here is at QB and WR. The Tide are avg 290 pass ypg and Sims is comp 65% of his passes w/a 15-3 ratio and he has by far the best WR in the country to throw to in Cooper (1,132 yds). On the other side, LSU is avg just 129 pass ypg their L/4 gms and Jennings is comp just 50% of his passes. We think Bama could be the best tm in the country when it's all said and done (we would favor them over any other tm on a neutral field) and we'll call for them to come away w/the win.

OKLAHOMA by 4 over Baylor - OU won the first 15 meetings in the series in Big 12 play although BU was 8-7 ATS. BU is now 2-1 SU and 3-0 ATS the L/3. LTH OU was -21' but only won 42-34. LY BU took OU's best punch and survived leading 24-5 at the half and dominated the 2H in a 41-12 win (-16'). They had a 459-237 yd edge and it was the largest underdog role Bob Stoops had been in his OU tenure. This is basically a Big 12 Title elimination gm for both tms, (OU already has 2 losses and this would even eliminate them from a big bowl gm). Both tms had a bye 2 wks ago and both routed inferior opponents LW as Baylor had 30-12 FD and 669-304 yd edges in a 60-14 (-35') win over Kansas while OU had 41-17 FD and 751-334 yd edges in their 59-14 win (-15') over Iowa St. They had 510 rushing yds (most s/89) and the offense had been inconsistent with Knight running less TY but LW they officially took off the restraints and he had 146 rush yds. This is the 1st time Baylor has been a dog since the 2012 Holiday Bowl, however, OU has never dropped B2B home games in the Stoops era (lost to KSt 3 wks ago in a very misleading gm) and we'll call for the Sooners to come away w/the win.

FLORIDA ST by 20 over Virginia - Homecoming. FSU is 14-3 SU all-time vs UVA but lost the LTH ('11, also last meeting) 14-13 (-17). The Seminoles were ranked #23 & all'd a 75/5pl GW td drive w/1:16 left as the Cavaliers won for the 1st time in Tallahassee (1-8 SU). That was their last win over a top 25 foe until their win over Lville earlier this ssn. We cashed our Thurs night CFB Marquee winner as FSU survived another DD deficit, this time 21-0 late 2Q, to turn back Lville 42-31 (-3.5) & remain alive for the College Football Playoff. The Noles did pile up 574 yds of offense against the then #1 D in the country! UVA is off a 35-10 (+4) loss at GT as they were outrushed 268-22. They never led & were shutout in the 2H. FSU is 18-11-1 as a HF under Fisher while UVA is 9-10 as an AD under London. The Noles do have a huge gm vs Miami on deck and we'll call this one near the line.

WKU by 4 over Utep - First meeting. Utep enters on a 3 gm winning streak, their longest s/10. The Miners 35-14 (-5) win over SM was misleading as they were actually outgd 402-234 but they benefitted from 5 TO's, had a 98 yd KOR td & scored 2 def td's in the 4Q. WKU wasn't so fortunate as they were overpowered 59-10 (+7) vs La Tech as we easily cashed a 4★ Key Selection on these pages. The Hilltoppers turned the ball over 5X and all'd a 96 yd KOR for a td as they were outFD'd 31-15 & outgd 507-297. WKU is on a 5-12 run as a HF and we always like playing on physical tms (UTEP) taking on pass-happy tms that can't play D.

OREGON ST by 10 over Washington St - This rivalry is actually one of the longest in the P12 at 98 gms. OSU is on a 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS run in this series while the visitor is on a 4-1 SU/5-0 ATS run. LY's game was misleading. OSU (E) won 52-24 but WSU led 24-17 w/4:50 left 3Q. Tied at 24, OSU went 27 yds for a td then got 3 int's which led to td's to blow it open. LTH ('12) OSU entered ranked #14 but only won 19-6 (-14'). The Cougars are off a 44-17 (+7') home loss to USC in which they lost FBS pass yds leader Halliday in the 1Q & he's OFY. That loss guaranteed WSU a non-winning ssn for the 11th str yr (avg wins the L10Y is 4). OSU is off a 45-31 (-4') homecoming loss to Cal, spoiling QB Mannion's record breaking performance as he became the P12's all-time leader in pass yds (USC's Matt Barkley 12,327). The Beavers were up 31-27 mid-4Q but the Bears, who rushed for a ssn high 269 yds, scored the gms final 18 pts. OSU is now 1-7 ATS on the ssn & is on a 7-12 run as a HF, while WSU is 8-4 as an AD under Leach incl an outright upset at Utah TY. Despite those technical edges for Wazzu, the Beavers' backs are against the wall here and now they will be facing a Wazzu tm that has nothing to play for and is missing their leader.

Over 33 years this play has been a reader favorite. The last 16 years the Underdog Play of the Week has recorded numerous **OUTRIGHT UPSET WINNERS (521) to the incredible record INCLUDING 4 in '13 incl 3 straight outright winners AND TWO THIS YEAR!!!!** Here is TW's Underdog Play:

UTAH +9' over Oregon

Oregon's only trip to Utah was '03 which they lost 17-13 (-3). LY Mariota was less than 100% and Utah st'd their bkp. UO led 17-7 (190-137 yd edge) at HT. Down 44-14 Utah went 64/8 for a td w/6:01 left for the backdoor cover (+28). UO is off their huge revenge game vs Stanford and is now travelling to play in the altitude and their 2nd road gm in 3 wks. They were able to end their 2 gm losing streak to the Cardinal in impressive fashion as they won going away 45-16 (-8) as we easily cashed our 3★ LPS. After Stanford got to within 8 in the 3Q, the Ducks scored 21 unanswered & have now won 31 str gms when scoring 30+ pts. Utah saw their playoff chances eliminated LW, falling to ASU 19-16 (+4) in OT. Usually reliable PK Phillips missed two 35 yd fg's (TO called just before 1st miss) in OT. The HT is 5-0 SU in this series w/the Ducks hosting 4 times. Utah is 3-1 ATS. Utah is a HD for the 1st time TY, but HC Whittingham is 7-3 in that role here and has pulled off some major upsets incl against a Top 5 Stanford tm LY. We wouldn't be shocked to see them do it again here.

Air Force by 6 over UNLV - AF is 9-3 SU in this series, but UNLV is 5-3 ATS while the HT is 8-1 ATS. There have been outright upsets each of the L2Y with LV winning the LTH ('12) 38-35 (+10) and LY in a game that was played in single digit temps and a wind chill below zero. LV still had a 471-298 yd edge and 30-17 FD edge winning 41-21 (+1). AF has never lost 3 str in this series. UNLV was down 17-0 vs NM LW, but scored a td w/11 left 1H to sieze momentum. After taking a 28-24 lead mid 4Q, the Rebels all'd a 3 yd td w/1:22 left. They had a chance to win but their 55 yd fg at the end fell just short. AF is off a 23-6 (-3) win at rival Army which awarded them the CIC Trophy for the 1st time s/'11 (19th overall) & made them bowl elig after missing the post-ssn LY for the 1st time s/'06. AF is the much better tm but the Falcons are 0-3 SU/0-4 ATS in the gm following Army, while UNLV under Hauck is 13-6-1 as a HD incl an outright upset over FSU TY & is on a 14-7 ATS run in MW action.

SAN DIEGO ST by 17 over Idaho - Just the 4th all-time meeting between these schools & the HT is 4-0 SU/ATS with the avg win by 18 ppg. LTH ('08) SDSSt won in a route 45-17 (-11'). The Aztecs are off a 30-14 (+4) loss at Nevada. Up 14-10 at HT, SDSSt all'd all 20 2H pts. ID is off a 44-28 (+17) home loss to Ark St. The Vandals had 8 TO's (4 int's, 4 fumb's) but led 28-24 late 3Q before all'g the final 20 pts. ID is -40 ypg & -11 ppg vs our #118 sked while SDSSt is +50 ypg & +2 ppg vs our #95 sked. As an AD prior to this yr, ID was on a 3-11 ATS run, but they're 4-0 in that role TY and we'll call for them to make it 5-0 ATS especially coming off a misleading gm LW.

Marshall by 24 over SOUTHERN MISS - These schools 1st met in 2005 & have pl'd every yr since. SM had been 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in this series but MU has now won 3 in a row SU/ATS pulling outright upsets in '11 (+7) 26-20 and '12 (+4) 59-24. LY MU scored td's on all 4 1Q drives & led 28-0. They finished w/636 yds & won 61-13 (-31'), which tied the most pts all'd in SM history ('87 vs FSU). Marshall is fresh off a bye following a 35-16 (-28) win over FAU (1st non ATS win s/opener) while SM is off a 35-14 (+5) loss at UTEP despite a 402-234 yd edge. The Golden Eagles committed 5 TO's & all'd a 98 yd KOR td & two 4Q def td's. Marshall is 1 of just 3 remaining undefeated FBS tms, but unfortunately have no shot at making the College Football Playoff (they do have a shot at making a major bowl gm and were aided by ECar's loss LW). The Thundering Herd will have to continue taking their frustrations out on overmatched CUSA opposition with SM being the latest.

Fau by 3 over NORTHTEXAS - Homecoming & the loser of this gm will be eliminated from bowl contention. Both were bowl elig LY, but only NT was invited. These schools know each other well. From 2004-'12 they were SBC rivals & now they're both in CUSA. NT was 0-6 SU in the series but has now won 3 str (3-6 all-time ATS). FAU is 4-1 SU/ATS all-time in Denton, but all their wins came at Fouts Field. LTH ('11) NT was -4 & led 7-0 at HT & 31-0 after 85 & 15 yd IR td's mid-3Q before all'g FAU to score the L/17 pts. NT enters fresh off a bye after a 41-21 (+14) loss at Rice while FAU enters off an emotional 31-28 (-3) loss vs UAB. Down 28-7 4Q, the Owls rallied to tie the gm at 28 before all'g a 24 yd fg w/0:2 left. FAU is on a 3-1 ATS run the week before their bye. We'll take the road tm here by a FG but they are a conf AF for just the 3rd time s/'10 (0-1 TY).

Georgia Southern by 9 over TEXAS ST - Only previous mtg was in the first round of the IAA playoffs in '05. TXSt hosted and won 50-35. GS is the surprise tm of the SBC as they remained undefeated in conf play after routing Troy 42-10 (-24) last Thursday, holding the Trojans to ssn lows of 9 FD & 154 yds. TXSt is off a 37-29 (-8) win over NMSSt despite being outFD'd 32-21 & outgd'd 639-430 as they ret'd a blk'd punt 10 yds for a td. Against 2 common foes in NMSSt & ID, GS is 2-0 SU/0-2 ATS, +16 ppg & +46 ypg while TXSt is 2-0 SU/0-2 ATS, +6 ppg & -133 ypg. GS is +140 ypg & +24 ppg vs our #126 sked & TXSt is -16 ypg & +5 ppg vs our #123 sked. The Golden Eagles get the win, but their lines have started to get inflated and it's tough laying DD's on a long road trip (see their gm vs NMSSt earlier TY).

ARIZONA by 21 over Colorado - Homecoming. LTH ('12) CU led 10-7 in the 2Q, all'd 42 of the next 49 pts and still covered losing 56-39 (+29). LY AZ had a 670-349 yd edge. Trailing 34-20 CU faked a punt at their own 18 and AZ turned it into a td and won 44-20 (-12'). AZ was essentially eliminated from the playoffs LW after falling short at UCLA 17-7 (+6). The Wildcats couldn't hang onto a 7-3 HT lead as they were held to a ssn low 255 yds, close to 300 yds under their ssn avg. CU is off a 38-23 (+5) loss to UW as they couldn't hang onto a 23-17 3Q lead. The Buff's were done in by 4 TO's, 1 ret'd for a td & also all'd an 87 yd PR td. We easily cashed a 3★ LPS selection on the OVER. Colorado is just 6-17 ATS as an AD and we still think Ariz is a legit tm, that will want to get LW's bad taste out of their mouths.

Boise St by 14 over NEW MEXICO - BSU is a perfect 5-0 SU in this series (2-3 ATS), while the home tm is 3-2 SU/2-3 ATS. LTH ('12) the Broncos (-25) only won by 3. BSU led 25-0 at HT, but NM cut the lead to 3 w/3:24 left but was stopped on 4&4 from their 33 (BSU ran out L/2:05). LY NM came in all'g 66 & 69 pts the 2W prior. Gm was 7-7 mid-1Q but BSU would score 2 td's before HT incl a 99 yd drive and went on to win 45-17 (-37). BSU enters fresh off a bye & a 55-30 (-6) win over BYU the week prior. NM comes in off a 31-28 (+1) win at UNLV, despite only 5 pass yds (fewest by a winning FBS tm s/'12, AF 0 vs Haw). Up 17-0, the Lobo's all'd a td w/1:11 left 2Q. Trailing 28-24, RB Gipson scored the GW td on a 3 yd run w/1:22 left & UNLV missed a 55 yd fg at the end. The Broncos are on a 28-12 run as an AF, but did lose outright to option based Air Force all'g 287 (4.8) rush yds earlier TY. Even though they've had extra time to prep and have seen option earlier TY, the Broncos have struggled with it and we'll give a slight lean to the HT.

COLORADO ST by 17 over Hawaii - CSU has won 5 in a row SU (by 24 ppg incl 2 shutouts) & is on a 3-0 ATS run in this series. LTH ('12) CSU was -6. Up 28-27 into 4Q, CSU got a 76 yd IR td w/14:36 left and then a 60 yd IR td w/1:17 left for the 42-27 win. UH had a 393-291 yd edge. LY CSU was -1' and was up 35-17 at HT, but was held to 95 yds in 2H. Down 35-28 w/1:25 left, Hawaii was SOD at the CSU45. The Rams are off a 38-31 (-7) win at SJSt as they all'd the Spartans to recover an onside kick with 2:19 left but the D held at the SJSt 41. The Rainbow Warriors are off a 35-14 (+2) loss vs UTSt. Hawaii all'd a true frosh making his 1st start to complete 14 of 15 passes incl his 1st 12, while turning the ball over 3X themselves. Under HC McElwain CSU is on an 8-4 run as a HF, but are 0-2 this yr as a MW HF. UH has lost 16 str road gms (7-9 ATS) and are 6-9 as an AD under Chow. We'll call for Col St to continue the Warriors woes here.

MICHIGAN ST by 3 over Ohio St - B10 GOY as the winner will be the fav to win the B10 Champ gm & in the running for a playoff appearance. OSU has won the L/4 meetings SU here (last loss in '99). This however, will be the 1st Nov. night gm in Spartan Stadium history. MSU is 10-5 SU all-time in night HG's (7-2 SU under Dantonio). Revenge will be on the minds of the Buckeyes as LY in the B10 Championship, they were a win away from a Nat'l Title appearance. MSU (+5) jumped out to a 17-0 lead but trailed 24-17 w/5:36 3Q. From that point MSU outgained OSU 227-46 (just 2 OSU FD's) scoring the final 17 pts. LTH ('12) OSU won 17-16 (+2). MSU is fresh off a bye while OSU is off a 55-14 (-28) route over Illinois. The Buckeyes led 31-0 at HT & tied their B10 reg ssn win streak with 20 str wins. MSU is 4-8 as a B10 HF, while Meyer is 2-0 as an AD at OSU incl winning here in '12. Despite those technical edges for the Bucks here, we'll call for this gm to go down to the wire with the home tm coming out w/a 3 pt win.

Louisiana by 16 over New Mexico St - Homecoming. When these two were in the SBC together from '01-'04, NMSSt actually won 3 of the L/4 but UL was 3-1 ATS. LY they met for the first time s/'04. UL was -31' at home but NMSSt led 28-14 at HT w/a 317-174 yd edge. UL got a td and 2 pt conv to take a 35-28 lead w/10:49 left & went on to win 49-35. UL is off a 19-9 (-7) win over USA, cashing a 3★ LPS winner for us. Down 9-6 at HT, the Ragin' Cajuns scored all 13 2H pts to remain in control in the SBC standings. 2nd of B2B home gms for NMSSt as they are off a 37-29 (+8) loss to TXSt despite 32-21 FD & 639-430 yd edges. QB Rogers had 2 costly int's & TXSt ret'd a blk'd punt 10 yds for a td. The Ragin' Cajuns have covered their L/3 SBC gms but this could be a bit of a flat spot here.

ARIZONA ST by 1 over Notre Dame - LY they met for the first time since 1999. ND was off their loss to Okla and AST was off a big win over USC. ND prob would have been favored the week prior but was +6'. ND led 24-13 but tied 27-27 ND got a fg w/3:03 left then a 14 yd IR td w/1:08 left. AST went 75/7 getting a 16 yd td w/1:11 left which gave them the ydg edge for the game. ND is 3-0 SU/ATS. A playoff elimination gm for both tms here as ND comes in 7-1 after their 49-39 win (-14) over Navy LW as we easily cashed a 3.5★ LPS College Totals play on the OVER. They scored on their 1st 4 poss and led 28-7 but allowed Navy to get back in the gm. The bigger loss for them was losing their leading tackler, emotional leader and the player who called all the D plays in LB Schmidt for the yr. Ariz St is fortunate to be where they are as they got a Hail Mary td pass to beat USC, faced Wash w/o QB and top 2 RB and won a nail biter and LW faced Utah w/o #1 WR and the Utes AA K did miss a 35-yd FG in OT. AST did have a 444-241 yd edge in their 19-16 win (-6'). We would have backed the Irish here but the injury to Schmidt means they could have as many as 4 true frosh st'g and we'll call for this to go down to the wire.

4★ NEW ORLEANS by 13 over San Francisco - This is one of the quiet NDIV rivalries in the NFL as including playoffs, this is the 8th meeting in 9 years. NO is 5-2 SU but on an 0-3-1 ATS mark beating SF 23-20 as a 3 pt HF LY. NO dominated the stat sheet with a 23-12 FD and 387-196 yd edge and forced SF to punt on their 1st 4 drives. The Saints settled for 3 FG's on 3 straight drives in the 4th Qtr to make the game closer than it should have. NO is reasserting themselves on the ground with Ingram being the 1st RB with 30 rush att's since Deuce in 2006. Over the L4 games the Saints have outgained foes by 102 yds and the maligned #20 defense has allowed an 80.2 QBR as well with a 3.7 ypc. SF was in a good situation LW vs a STL team on the road for the 2nd straight with another DIV foe on deck. The defense did it's part holding STL to 193 yds with 2 TO's setting up 7 pts. However, the OL gave up 8 sacks, Gore/Hyde only had 16 rush att's and Kaepernick was rattled all game long. Brees is starting to gain momentum (104.6 QBR L3) and now SF has to venture into a hostile venue vs a team that at 4-4 can't take anything for granted and the home team is the play.

3★ Denver by 21 over OAKLAND - Is this line too big? Not for a DEN/OAK game as the Broncos are 5-0 ATS with a 34-16 avg score and 467-315 avg yd edge. Manning is on a 4-0 SU/ATS run after facing the Patriots and the Broncos are 13-1 SU/10-4 ATS vs the AFC West with him at the helm. Manning has 199 more yards passing than the Raiders do as an entire team on offense. DEN WR's Thomas and Sanders have 1679 yds receiving vs 1840 yds for OAK as a team. Manning has only been sacked 9 times with DEN outrushing foes by 22 yds (3.7). The Raiders have only earned 8 sacks and have been outrushed by 67 yds TY. Don't read into LW's matchup vs SEA too much as the Seahawks were very thin on the OL (down 2 starter entering) and couldn't find a rhythm. DEN has covered 6 straight off a SU loss with a 38-19 avg score (+202 yds) and while Carr has a lot of promise (79.8 QBR) despite the talent around him this has the makings of a blowout here.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ NY Giants (+) over SEATTLE - This is a tough spot for the Giants off MNF vs Luck then having to travel to SEA here with SF at home on deck. The Giants are 5-11 ATS on the road being outgained by 91 ypg on the road (+3 TO's). The Giants have this game circled as they were shutout 23-0 at home LY by SEA who snared 5 ints. SEA dominated every facet of the game with a 21-12 FD and 327-181 yd edge as the Giants were held to just 25 yds (1.8) rushing. SEA did hold onto beat OAK LW but they didn't put them away as expected despite a 100 yd edge and 3 TO's turned into 10 pts. SEA's OL is very depleted right now (down their starting Ctr/LT) and Lynch has only broken the 100 yd rush once TY and that was back in Wk 1. SEA is also avg 9 pen's since Wk 1 and combined with the OL Wilson has struggled to get in rhythm LW (179 yds 49%). SEA is a beat up bunch and this is a lot of points to give up in a year where fav's of 7.5 or more are 8-11 ATS and we'll take the dog here.

OTHER GAMES

Cleveland at Cincinnati - Thursday While CLE last won a division road game in 2009, losing 15 straight, they also gone 1-1-1 ATS their last 3 trips here outgaining CIN by 85 ypg the L/2. You do have Cincy 13-0-1 SU/11-1-1 ATS at home and they used LW to rest RB Bernard and get the rust off AJ Green. The national tv spotlight has been special for CLE appearing only once each of the L4Y covering the L/3 and we'll have a marquee selection on this for Thursday.

Dallas by 7 over JACKSONVILLE - The Cowboys haven't been a DD favorite since mid-2011 and are 1-6 ATS prior to their bye week. The Jags proudly claim the UK as their secondary market but have only won the yardage battle 3 times in their L12 road games (1-4 ATS run) being outgained by 94 ypg TY. DAL tends to play down to their foes only outgaining them by 21 ypg TY and while they are 4-1 SU they are just 3-2 ATS vs teams with a losing record. They do have sizeable stat ranking edges over the Jaguars (+35 yds vs -74 yds). This is a step down in talent for DAL after the L6 games but after Weeden's efforts vs ARZ (183 yds 55% 1-2) Romo is making the 9 hour flight to play. Over the L4W JAX has a respectable +38 ypg but Bortles has a 62.4 QBR. The Jaguars defense is doing its part bringing pressure (27 sacks #2) but they only have a 15-5 ratio (95.7 QBR #23) and are now facing Dez Bryant who had 15 yds (7.5) on 10 targets LW. JAX's role as the NFL's youngest team catches up to them again as they go from CIN to the UK while DAL was home for 3 straight but the Cowboys will be happy escaping with a win.

DETROIT by 1 over MIAMI - DET is 7-3 after their bye which they truly needed as they were down to just 2 active DT's vs ATL. DET is only 3-7 ATS as a HF but they are expected to welcome back Bush/Megatron as well as the top 3 TE's that sat out vs the Falcons. Those injuries have produced the very unusual #19 offense and #1 defense rankings for the Lions (+1 TO's). In looking at DET's 4 covers they beat Bridgewater in his 2nd career start after an extended layoff, beat the erratic Jets as a 1 pt AF, handled the Packers at home as a 1.5 pt HF and got the Giants in Manning's 1st game in a diff system in 10 years. MIA has their warts in their covers also but their defense has seen Brady, Alex Smith, Rodgers, Cutler and Rivers with a 79.4 QBR. LW's results didn't move the line value here which is a surprise and coming off a bye isn't a big deal with HF's of 7 or less being 3-7-1 ATS. We'll take the points especially since offensive teams need 1.5 Qtrs to get up to speed.

BUFFALO by 1 over Kansas City - The Bills return from their bye week one win short of tying their win total for each of the L3Y. Orton has been at the helm for 4 games with Bills avg 333 ypg which would be roughly 21st on the year and has taken 17 sacks. Lost in the meltdown victory over the Jets is that they only had 67 yds rushing (2.9) and they've given up 158 yds (5.5) and 175 yds (5.3) the L2 games rushing. KC has four quality covers on the road vs DEN, MIA, SF and SD with a decent 93.1 opposing QBR with a +22 ypg mark (11th). Smith is a risk averse QB (94.8 QBR) and while he won't put up big stats (255 yds vs DEN is season high) he doesn't need to with the #6 rush game. KC has held 3 straight QB's to under 7.0 ypa, are 2nd in sacks by (27) and their 33% 3rd Dn rate on defense is 3rd (KC 2d on offense). The dog is 6-2 ATS in BUF games TY who have a surprising 79.5 defensive QBR and we'll side with the Bills who are 9-4 ATS as a HD.

BALTIMORE by 14 over Tennessee - This is the 1st time TEN has been a dog off a bye since losing 31-28 to JAX (+4) in 2005. They are 2-5 SU/ATS on the road losing by an avg score of 27-18 but BAL is 2-5 ATS after facing PIT. TEN has only covered vs KC which is clearly an anomaly and WAS thanks to 2 TO's which forced a QB switch. TEN has been outgained by 42 ypg on the road TY and we have a rookie QB in Mettenberger off a bye and in his 1st career road start here. He wasn't as good as his stats indicated vs HOU as he had just 217 yds (60%) 1-1 prior to his final drive. TEN has also been outrushed 131 (4.4) to 61 (3.1) in their 3 games prior to the bye vs JAX, WAS, HOU who aren't offensive juggernauts. BAL has been held to

The Ravens have brought the hammer to lower tier teams TY beating CAR, TB, ATL by a 38-11 mark with a 122 yd edge. This is a big game for BAL as if they're off 2 losses this is must win & they have nothing to hold back with a bye on deck.

Pittsburgh by 6 over NY JETS - This is a huge flat spot for PIT who are only 3-8 ATS as an AF. PIT is off the CLE loss, HOU on MNF, a shootout vs IND and LW's SNF vs BAL with a MNF at TEN on deck. PIT does have a massive edge with Roethlisberger (105.6 QBR) vs a Jets defense with an inflated ranking (#6) due to being -15 in TO's giving them short fields to defend. The Jets #112.8 defensive QBR is 32nd (24-1 ratio!!!) and they are 32nd in defensive ypg. Ryan has to continually blitz (#5 sacks by) to try and take the pressure off his DB's who struggle to keep up. PIT WR Antonio Brown has more yards receiving (852) than the Jets top 2 receivers in Decker and Amaro combined (711). Vick moved the ball fairly well vs KC (196 yds 75% 1-0) on the surface but 110 yds was in the final 4:56 down 14. PIT is used to being blitzed continuously which only will only aggravate Roethlisberger but the Jets lack the firepower on offense to keep up with him in a shootout here.

Atlanta by 3 over TAMPA BAY - The Falcons have won 4 straight covering 3 coming off a bye week. They've had 2 weeks to simmer after blowing a 21 pt lead to DET and now get a TB team that has only recorded 21 pts in two games TY. With a 1-11 SU/3-9 ATS mark on the road thanks to an injury depleted OL Ryan's QBR in the 5 games away from home is 80.5. The Falcons have given up 144 ypg (3.9) rushing TY and simply can't rush the passer and in their 5 game losing streak they have just 5 sacks in 170 pass att's. The Bucs outgained a foe for the 1st time TY vs CLE but self-destructed on special teams with a blocked FG, tipped punt, costly penalty by All-Pro DT McCoy to give CLE the lead. TB has been brutal in their 3 Div games getting outgained 444-265 (-2 TO's) being lucky in Brees' errors in the OT game. Neither team is especially appealing at this point but the line shift here has us lean to the visitor getting points with the better QB here.

ARIZONA by 9 over St Louis - This is the 1st HF role of a TD or more for ARZ since the end of 2009 also vs STL which they won 31-10 (-15). ARZ is 8-3-1 ATS at home and 10-2 ATS after a SU win despite not playing big stat football (#23 and #19 units). ARZ has simply been playing solid ball on 3rd Dns (#5 offense #13 defense), they have a real OL as Palmer has only been sacked 6 times on 188 pass att's and Andre Ellington quietly has the 8th most rush yds TY (559 3.8). Defensively they have a solid secondary (83.1 QBR #9) and haven't allowed a 100 yd rusher in 18 straight games. STL brought relentless pressure vs SF LW notching 8 sacks and giving Kaepernick happy feet in the pocket. STL was outgained by 70 yds and a rare goal line fumble on a QB sneak let them escape with the win. Dogs off a SU win as a 10 pt dog are 5-10 ATS and LW's victory means they won't sneak up on ARZ (6-1 ATS vs foe off SU win). The Cardinals are a quality team with a veteran QB playing at high level that will have a solid homefield edge vs a STL team in their 3rd road game in 4 Wks with DEN on deck at home.

Chicago at Green Bay - Mike McCarthy became the GB HC in 2006 and the one constant in his 8 season is that the Packers cover after their bye week going 8-0 ATS. However, you do have to worry about an inflated line as in their first meeting TY the Bears had a 33-21 FD edge and a 496-358 yard edge but were -2 TO's allowing GB to score 17 2H pts with 3 drives 35 yds or less. That game was the 4th straight in which the visitor has covered in the series.

Carolina at Philadelphia - Monday - The Panthers would like to roll back the calendar to Oct 12 when going to the 4Q vs Cincy they led 24-17 but missed a FG. Since that tie they've dropped 3 straight and hold the dubious distinction of being the only team to get outgained in every game since the opener. It's time for Carolina to put up or shut up but when they've been a AD of 7+ pts the L3Y they are 3-0 ATS covering by over 6 ppg. Keep in mind the Eagles that under Kelly the Eagles are 1-4 as a HF of 5 or more covering vs only JAX in the opener TY and losing outright to SD, NYG and MIN LY.
