4★ UTEP over North Texas - These two Texas schools are 640 miles apart & LY was their 1st meeting in 33 yrs. NT recorded 8 sks, had a 471-184 yd edge, blk'd a punt and a fg in the 41-7 (-25) win. This is the 1st meeting in El Paso s/1980. UTEP blew a 13 pt late 3Q lead & all'd the final 21 pts in their 35-27 (+8) loss at WKU. The Miners had the FD, yds & TOP edges but all'd a 90 yd IR td that gave WKU their 1st lead. The Mean Green are off a 31-10 (+4) homecoming win over FAU. They held FAU to just 12 FD & 197 tl yds. The Miners are 4-1 as a HF under HC Kugler incl 3-0 TY & have covered 5 str at the Sun Bowl. NT is 0-4 as an AD TY. Prior to LW's misleading UTEP loss and NT's dominating win, this line may have been DD's. UTEP can clinch bowl elig w/a win here and they have dominated the LOS the L/3 wks and have held their opp's to just 65 rush ypg. NT's road/away dichotomy is the final rubber stamp as they are +63 ypg at home and -177 ypg on the road. **While we've never used either tm as a GOY in our history, there's always something sentimental about your first... Will we make the Miners our next memorable 5★ GOY?**

FORECAST: UTEP by 14

3★ Florida St over MIAMI - UM won 6 in a row SU in this series from '00-'04 (1 bowl) but FSU is 7-2 SU, 5-4 ATS since. There was a streak of 6 str and 8 of 9 outright upset wins from '02-'10 and that's why the dog is now 8-1 ATS with LY's FSU (-21) cover being the first for a favorite s/01. It's good to see these two meeting in big games again. FSU is on their 2nd AG in 3 wks while UM is fresh off bye. LY was #3 FSU vs #7 UM & it was the first time two top 10 tms met that one was fav'd by 3 td's s/95. RB Duke Johnson broke his ankle and was OFY in the 3Q as FSU went onto win 41-14. FSU was down early (again) vs UVA, but went onto win 34-20 (-19) which was their school rec 25th str. After starting the ssn 3-3 SU/2-4 ATS, UM has found itself & has won 3 str SU/ATS, covering the spread by an avg of 12 ppg. While the Noles are 2-7 ATS TY, one of those covers came the L/time they were on the road and laying a reasonable number as they outscored L'ville 42-10 down the stretch, the same L'ville team that beat Miami by 18 TY. Also notable is the fact the Noles usually travel well here as they've won their L/4 here. The Champs are getting disrespected w/this number under a FG and we think they play w/a chip on their shoulders here.

FORECAST: Florida St by 6

3★ ARKANSAS ST over Appalachian St - First meeting. After a loss to FCS Liberty, App St has now won 3 str conf tms and were fortunate LW in their 31-29 (-4) win over ULM. They were down 20-7 in the 1H but got a TD w/06 left to go up 21-20 at the break. ULM got a TD w/1:42 left in the 4Q but missed a 2 pt conv and 2 pass interf calls helped App St go 53/7pl for 39 yd FG w/29 left. We still cashed a 3★ LPS going against them. On the other side, Ark St is off a 45-10 win (-10) over South Alabama. They moved to 4-0 ATS as a HF TY and are on a 20-2 SU run at home the L/4 yrs. It doesn't matter who is on the sidelines coaching the Red Wolves as their players are used to the changes every yr and just win (already bowl eligible and will be favored in their 3 remaining gms). We'll call for them to get another dominating win here vs an App St tm that has been feeding on some of the SBC weaklings in recent wks.

FORECAST: ARKANSAS ST by 20

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ SMU (+) over Usf - Homecoming in Dallas. These schools met for the 1st time LY in Tampa & SMU led 16-0 before winning 16-6 (-4). USF enters fresh off a bye & this is the 1st of B2B AG's. SMU remained the only winless FBS tm in the nation after their 38-28 loss (+13) at Tulsa. They did get the backdoor cover after trailing 35-13 at one pt as their dismal offense was jump-started by A&M trans QB Matt Davis who had 181 yds rushing and 212 yds passing and gives them new life vs a Bulls D that is all'g 511 ypg on the road TY. The Bulls are also on a 3-12 ATS run as an AF and they have not won by more than 10 pts on the road s/11. They are just 3-11 SU on the road and we think SMU w/Davis under Ctr could be a tm fully capable of putting up some yds and pts as we learned the hard way LW.

FORECAST: Usf by 3

2★ WISCONSIN over Nebraska - A game of the year weekend wouldn't be the same without these two tms. Since 2000, we have cashed a total of **FOUR 5★ College GOY's combined on these 2 teams incl one our favorites of all time, Wisky's 62-14 win (-7) over Indiana in 2012.** This game will likely serve as an elimination gm to represent the West Div in the B10 Champ game. These schools last pl'd in the 2012 B10 Champ gm. Wisconsin led 42-10 at HT & went onto win 70-31 (+3). Nebraska enters fresh off a much needed bye as RB Abdullah was inj'd vs Purdue, but he's expected to play here. They're 3-0 ATS as an AD the L2Y w/2 outright upsets & has covered 6 str away from Lincoln. However, one of those ATS wins was a bit misleading as earlier TY, Mich St led Neb 24-3 in the 4Q and took their foot off the pedal. The Badgers enter off B2B B10 AG's & beat Purdue 34-16 (-17) LW cashing another Early Bird POW winner (given out FREE every Monday on button #9 by calling 1-347-677-1700). Both tms have dominant rush offenses, but Wisconsin is all'g just 84 rush ypg at home while Nebraska is all'g 137 rush ypg on the road. The Badgers have the better D, they're at home and look for them to make a statement in the Big Ten race w/a DD win. **The only question remains, will we go back to them for yet another GOY?**

FORECAST: WISCONSIN by 10

Wednesday, November 12th

Ball St at MASSACHUSETTS - The L/meeting ('88) took place in Muncie and Ball St won 44-17. The Minutemen haven't played in 18 days, but they did cover their L/5 gms prior to their double bye and they are much better than their 2-7 SU record indicates as they have lost 5 gms by 7 pts or less. Ball St is 3-6 SU/4-5 ATS on the ssn and we cashed a Wed Night Marquee going against them LW in their 35-21 loss (+3) to N Ill. The gm was a bit misleading as the Cards had 5 TO's. While this will be only the 2nd time UMass has played at its home campus stad in Amherst at the FBS level, Ball St is a very dangerous away dog going 28-9 ATS s/06.

Kent St at BOWLING GREEN - The visitor is 7-2 SU (5-4 ATS) in this series. KSU won their last 2 trips here 30-6 (-2) in '10 and 31-24 (+2) in '12. LY BG got revenge for that heartbreaking '12 loss (MAC East Title was decided) and won 41-22 (-6). TY the Falcons have run the table vs MAC East foes and LW's 27-10 (+6) win at Akron gives them breathing room. Kent St is winless in conf play but we did cash a Tue Night Marquee on them LW in their 30-20 loss to UT (+13). Will BG stay focused vs the Flashes with I-75 rival Toledo on deck?

Thursday, November 13th

East Carolina at CINCINNATI - Both come in off a bye and both are on top of the logjam called the AAC with a 4-way tie in terms of conf losses thanks to EC's upset loss at Temple (gave us another Big Dog outright upset winner!). However, you have to respect Pirates HC McNeill as he's rallied his troops off a SU loss covering NINE straight over 4 seasons. Deciding matchup could be UC's new found rush attack, which after avg 96 ypg & 3.6 ypc the F/5 has avg'd 259 ypg & 5.9 ypc the L/3 gms. Meanwhile EC's rush D is allowing just 73 ypg (2.7) on the ground in conf action. Who stays on top in the AAC?

Southern Miss at UTSA - First Meeting. The Eagles' pass game was clicking with Nick Mullins leading the way to 4 covers in 5 games before an inj. They've now dropped 3 str w/out him after LW's 63-17 loss (+25) to Marshall and he could be back for this one (CS). On the other side, UTSA is one of TY's biggest disappointments at 2-7 and they've had QB inj issues of their own as they are avg just 10 ppg in their L/5 gms and LW ended a streak of 7 str scoreless quarters in their 17-7 loss (+9) to Rice. With both tms officially eliminated from bowl contention, which tm is motivated here?

California at USC - USC has now won 10 in a row SU (8-2 ATS) and they've also covered the L/5 meetings. Both are off a bye but USC has rival UCLA on deck. Home for the Cal Bears is on the road as they are 4-0 ATS TY pulling 3 upsets. A matchup of underrated QB's here as USC's Kessler is avg 283 ypg (70%) w/a 25-2 ratio while Cal's Goff is avg 346 ypg (63%) w/a 27-4 ratio. USC does have the much better D (#11-95) and has owned the series, but Cal should be fired up here as they try to clinch bowl eligibility w/a rare Nat'l ESPN appearance.

Friday, November 14th

Tulsa at UCF - Tulsa has won and covered 4 str in the series. The L/gm was for the '12 CUSA Title. UCF led 27-21 into the 4Q. UT tied the gm on a 54 yd PR td (inadvertent whistle as UCF players stopped). In OT, UCF had a fg blk'd (UT id 5pl later). We cashed a 3★ LPS against the Knights in their L/outing as they lost outright to UConn 37-29 (-9). They will have extra time to prep for this one off a bye and only have SMU on deck. LW The Golden Hurricane led SMU 35-13 at one pt but got back doored in their 38-28 win (-13'). Now they have to travel on a short week, but despite their poor record, they are a solid +23 ypg in AAC play.

Saturday, November 15th

NORTH CAROLINA by 3 over Pittsburgh - Homecoming in Chapel Hill. Both come in fresh off bye. LY NC (E) was catching Pitt off their emotional win over ND. Pitt was down 27-3 in the 3Q but came back to tie it before NC got a 61 yd PR td w/4:46 left. Pitt's last drive came up short as they were SOD at the NC27 w/1:10 left. This will be Pitt's 1st AG in 42 days and they are on a 3-7 ATS run on the road. NC HC Fedora is 9-6 as a HF, but the Tar Heels are 0-2 in that role TY. Pitt is +42 ypg in ACC play while the Tar Heels are -84 ypg. Prior to their blowout loss to Miami in their L/outing, the Tar Heels looked like they were turning back the clocks to LY as after a poor start, they had covered 3 str gms. On the other side, after a 3-0 start, the Panthers have lost 5 of 6 and have failed to cover 6 of their L/7 gms. In their L/gm, their K Blewitt, literally "blew it" for them by missing a chip shot FG at the end of reg that would have given them a win over Duke. Two very similar desperate tms needing a win and we'll back the home tm by a FG here.

NC STATE by 13 over Wake Forest - The HT is an outstanding 16-2 SU/15-3 ATS in this series. There have been 8 outright upsets in that span with WF pulling 7 and the Demon Deacons are 7-4 SU the last 11Y. LY NCSt was -7 on the road. WF came in struggling but we had an Underdog POW on WF on these pages as NCSt came in 0-12 ATS as a conf AF and we also liked playing on the series history backing the HT. WF led 21-10 7:18 3Q and got a td w/10:43 left to get the outright upset 28-13. TY WF just had a bye and a Thur night game the L2W while NCSt just faced GT's option LW but does have a bye on deck. LW WF was outgained 427-119 and had just 7 rush yds but still covered thanks to 2 Clem TO's setting up short TD drives. On the other side, in the 2Q, NC St ran 22 straight offensive plays but were outscored 14-0 in that span which was a key sequence in their 56-23 loss (+4) to Ga Tech. They are 5-1 SU/ATS in their FHG and it shouldn't be too hard to get them motivated here as they are playing with revenge and a win here gets them to bowl eligibility after a 3-9 '13 ssn.

PENN ST by 9 over Temple - Penn St's last loss to Temple came all the back in 1941. The Nittany Lions have won 30 str incl a 24-13 (-7) victory in the L/gm ('12). Both tms come in at 5-4 and would love nothing better than to clinch bowl eligibility as the Owls have gone 6-17 the L/2 yrs while Penn St has missed out on a bowl the L/2 yrs despite winning records thanks to their probation. LW both of these tms were in ugly gms as Temple blew a 10-0 lead and lost 16-13 (+7) on a L/second FG to Memphis. After a 4-1 start, their offense is avg just 14 ppg and 243 ypg in the L/4. Penn St is off a 13-7 win (-6) over Indiana as they had a 330-221 yd edge but 92 of that came on a TD run by Belton. While the Penn St D is holding their opp to 129 ypg less than what they are avg on the ssn (#3 in the country), their offense is avg just 14 ppg in regulation the L/5 wks and just 254 ypg. After sensational frosh yrs, both QB's have struggled TY as Penn St's Hackenberg has a 7-12 ratio (20-10 LY) while Temple's PJ Walker has an 11-10 ratio (20-8 LY). Tough to lay more than a TD here as this could be the lowest scoring gm of the wk.

Ohio St by 17 over MINNESOTA - UM has lost 8 str (2-6 ATS) vs OSU and the L/7 were all by 13+. The L/time the Bucks lost in MN was in '81 and since then, they have won 12 str trips by 17 ppg. LTH ('10) OSU won 52-10 (-25). UM is off their rivalry gm vs Iowa LW & have road gms w/NeB & Wisky on deck. However, this could be tough for the Bucks to get back up for this road gm after their biggest gm of the yr LW. After Minny blew out the Hawkeyes early in the day LW (51-14, -1), we were hoping for a Buckeyes loss to Sparty at night, which would have given us some line value here. However, after their offense torched a tough MSU D for 568 yds and 49 pts, you can kiss that value goodbye. With that being said, the Buckeyes have still covered 6 of their L/7 gms, have posted at least 49 pts and 545 yds in those 6 covers and we think the Golden Gophers will struggle with the Buckeyes speed much like in their 23 pt loss to TCU earlier TY.

Iowa by 8 over ILLINOIS - The Illini are just 3-8 SU/5-5-1 ATS vs the Hawkeyes s/'96. However, this is just another example of how conf realignment/expansion is frowned upon by us as amazingly these two "conf rivals" have not met since 2008, a 27-24 (-2) Illini win. Illinois comes in off a bye after a 55-14 (+28) loss to Ohio St two wks ago. HC Beckman still resides on the hot seat as the Illini are 4-5 but he has a chance to cool that seat in the L/3 wks with gms against Penn St and NW on deck. On the other side, Iowa was shockingly blown out by Minnesota LW 51-14 (+1) as they were held to a ssn-low 84 rush yds. They were on an 8-1 ATS run on the road prior. That rush attack, which has underperformed for most of the yr (148, 3.8) could be in store for a big bounce back effort here against an Illinois rush D that has all'd 335 rush ypg (6.8) in Big Ten play. Also notable is that the Hawkeyes are +70 ypg in conf play while Illinois is -196 ypg.

WKU by 9 over Army - LY was the first meeting. WKU had already faced Navy and worked on the option s/spring. WKU went 87/10 and got a td w/32 left to pull out the 21-17 (-6) win. Army had a 347-333 yd edge. Both tms come in off much needed wins as Army got its 1st win at Yankee Stadium s/1960. After leading 28-14 over UConn, the Huskies got a TD w/2:06 left, recovered the onside kick, and were threatening to tie the game up before the Knights got a 99-yd IR td w/28 left. On the other side, WKU down 27-21 got a 90 yd IR TD (14 pt swing) which keyed a 35-27 (-8) win. The Hilltoppers did face the option earlier TY and while they beat Navy 36-27 (+7), they did allow 412 rush yds (7.9). Their D ranks #126 in the country all'g 132 ypg more than what their opp are avg. Both tms still have a shot at getting to bowl eligibility (Army has Fordham and a bye on deck), but we can't back the Knights who despite winning LW in a neutral setting, have lost 19 str true road gms (1-18 ATS) while WKU has had success on the scoreboard vs the academies in the L/2 yrs.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 21 over Eastern Michigan - 50th all-time meeting. WM was 12-2 SU from '97-'10 but EM has pulled 3 consecutive outright upsets in this series and in fact, are 10-5 ATS incl 4 str covers in a game that helps determine the Michigan MAC Title. LY EM fired HC English during the week but the Eagles won 35-32 (+2) in OT. EM has never won 4 str in this series. EM is on a 4-13-1 run as an AD & have lost 6 str MAC AG's (0-5-1 ATS). Ironically their last conf road win was here in 2012. WM has covered 8 str gms overall TY (only ATS loss by 1/2 pt in opener) & they're on a 9-4 ATS run as a HF. Both teams enter fresh off a bye & surprisingly they haven't pl'd any common foes. The Broncos are +108 ypg in MAC play & are avg 208 rush ypg at home while EM is -203 ypg in MAC play & are avg 239 rush ypg (5.7) on the road. Tough to lay too many pts here in a rivalry gm that the underdog Eagles have owned, but we believe WM is the real deal TY.

TENNESSEE by 9 over Kentucky - Back in 1986, we used a 5★ College GOY on Tennessee vs Kentucky and the Vols won 28-9 (-5). UT is fresh off a bye while UK is playing for an 8th straight week and this is their 3rd road game in the last 5. LY UT led 27-7 when they fmb'd at the UKs with 10:58 left. After a punt, UK went 99/12 for a td with 3:41 left, which all'd them to only be outgained 417-393 as UT won 27-14 (-3). The Vols have now won 14 in a row SU here and are on a 28-1 SU run in this series s/'85. They are also an outstanding 14-4 ATS in this series s/'96. LW the Wildcats played an angry UGA tm off a shocking loss to UF and were destroyed 63-31 (+10) as we easily cashed another TV Totals play on the OVER (TV Side/Total POW's now 9-0 100% the L/4 wks, get these two plays for just \$9 on Saturdays at 10 am ET on your VIP Debit System). After a 5-1 start, the Cats who have less depth than most SEC schls are starting to wear down w/4 str losses. On the other side, the Vols should be rejuvenated after a bye. In their L/gm, they had a 0.2% chance of winning late in the 4Q down 42-28 to SCar. They got a TD w/1:50 left, recovered the outside K and got a TD w/1:11 left to tie and they eventually won in OT. QB Dobbs was the story as he was 23-40-301-2-1 while also adding 166 rush (6.9). The loser of this gm likely goes home for the holidays and we'll play against a run-down UK squad that has lost 19 str SEC road gms (4-14 ATS, 1 NL).

RUTGERS by 7 over Indiana - First meeting. The Scarlet Knights come in off a much-needed bye as they were destroyed by the Big Ten's elite by a combined 135-41. In their L/gm, they were shutout for the 1st time s/'02 (147 gms) in a 37-0 loss (+12) to Wisconsin as a banged up QB Nova was just 5-15-46. He should be healthier here. On the other side, Indy has now lost 4 str gms and LW failed to score an offensive td in their 13-7 loss (+6) to Penn St. QB Diamond was 13-28-68-0-2 and RB Coleman was held under 100 yds rushing for the 1st time in 10 gms. Gotta feel that Rutgers off a bye will put all their eggs into one basket here, as a win makes them bowl eligible in their 1st year in the Big Ten while Indy's once high-powered offense is a shell of itself w/ a undersized frosh QB that is avg just 34 pass ypg in his 3 starts and tms can now start keying in more on RB Coleman.

Clemson by 3 over GEORGIA TECH - CU had a bye 2 wks ago to sneak in some extra prep on GT. GT does have a bye next wk but CU only plays Georgia St. CU is 3-1 SU/ATS and the HT is 4-0 SU/ATS. CU has lost their last 4 trips to Bobby Dodd Stadium despite being favored in 2 of them. LY CU had an extra week to prep for the option and we used the Tigers (-10') as our Thur night Marquee. GT didn't get a FD until the 2Q and trailed 20-0. The 2 tms pretty much traded scores after that as Clem won 55-31. TY both tms come in red hot as the Yellow Jackets have won/covered 3 str (all by 25 pts or more) after LW's 56-23 win (-4) over NC State. The gm was close early until an IR TD for GT swung the momentum. On the other side, Clemson had a dominating 427-119 yd edge but only beat WF 34-20 (-21) as 2 Clem TO's set up 2 short WF TD drives. They have now failed to cover in all 4 of Stoudt's starts s/QB Watson was inj'd. However, he could return here and that could be dangerous for their foes considering Clemson's ranks #2 in the country in Total D and is all'g just 69 rush ypg (2.0!) in conf play. If Florida St makes it to the CFB Playoff, this is basically an elimination gm for the ACC's guaranteed spot in the Orange Bowl. If Watson is indeed back here, we'll back the Tigers and play against a GT tm that is just 4-9 ATS as a HD s/'04.

DUKE by 6 over Virginia Tech - Great spot for VT here. Duke is off pair of AG's and has rival NC on Thur on deck. VT is fresh off a bye and playing with legit revenge as LY Duke beat a ranked team for the first time s/'94 (had lost 47 str) and beat one on the road for the first time s/'71. VT down 3, missed a 40-yd FG and was int'd at the Duke43 on their L/2 poss as they lost 13-10 (-12'). While the situation and revenge factors are in VT's favor here, the on-the-field product is not as these two programs continue to head in opposite directions. After their upset win over Ohio St, VT is 1-6 ATS and have lost 3 str gms. On the other side, Duke is 16-1 SU/13-3-1 ATS in the reg ssn dating back to LY and while it isn't pretty (-105 ypg in ACC play), they find a way to get it done mostly due to outstanding coaching, winning the TO battle (+9) and great ST's. LW they beat Syracuse 27-10 (-4) but more important to us is that we easily cashed a College LPS Totals play on the UNDER. While VT finds itself a dog in this series (been a DD fav in each of the L/10 ACC meetings), it's tough backing a tm that has an erratic QB, a beat-up D and quite "Frankly" an over-the-hill HC who has seen the game pass him by in the L/efw yrs.

AIR FORCE by 3 over Nevada - The HT is 2-0 SU in this series but AF is 2-0 ATS. LTH (12) AF won 48-31 (-3'). LY they were +11' on the road and down to their 3rd string QB Carson Roberts (5-10-55). Roberts did rush for 161 yds, the most by a QB here s/'01. AF appeared to have the game won but blew a 42-31 4Q lead and lost 45-42. Both tms are still in the mix for a MW Div Title but the loser will most likely be eliminated. AF is one of the MIP tms in the country TY as they come in 7-2 (just 2-10 LY!) after we easily cashed a 3★ LPS on them LW in their 48-21 win (-5) over UNLV as they led 31-14 at HT. On the other side, Nev comes in fresh off a bye after 3 str wins/covers and outscored SDSt 20-0 in the 2H in their L/gm. Despite their 6-3 record, they are actually getting outscored 181-151 in the 1st 3 Qtrs of their gms. However, they have the nation's best ppg differential in the 4Q outscoring their foes 118-45! Look for this to go down to the wire and we'll take the HT by a FG.

Texas St at SOUTH ALABAMA - LY in their first ever meeting, TSt appeared in control jumping out to a 14-0 lead and led 27-17 with 7:39 left. TSt got a 43 yd fg w/2:28 left to go up 30-24 but SA got a 43 yd td pass with 1:29 left for a 31-30 lead. TSt had a 4&24 but got a 57 yd pass to the 23 and got a 41 yd fg w/0:4 left to pull out the win as a 1' pt HD. Both tms come in at 5-4 and will be vying for one of the SBC's bowl slots. LW TXSt nearly pulled off a shocker (not to us as we had the Bobcats as one of our Big Dog POW's, which you can get for just \$9 on your VIP Debit system on Wednesdays) as they lost to Ga Southern 28-25 (+14). The had a 439-268 yd edge but the key play was a GS 100-yd IR td that gave them a 28-10 lead on the final play of the 3Q. S Bama was playing w/o QB Bridge LW and the bkps were a combined 9-25-90-0-3 as they were outgained 400-201 in their 45-10 loss (+10) at Ark St. TXSt is 3-0 ATS on the road TY w/2 upsets while SA is 0-3-1 ATS at home. However, w/QB Bridge's status unknown at presstime, we'll pass on this matchup for now.

Tcu by 27 over KANSAS - In Big 12 meetings, TCU is now 2-0 SU but their wins have been by 14 and 10 and they've been favored by 20' and 24' so they are 0-2 ATS. LY TCU did have a 17-7 FD edge and 380-190 yd edge but also had 5 TO's. They got a 37 yd fg w/2:34 left to clinch it 27-17. The Frogs are off a big home game vs Kansas St and have Texas on Thanksgiving on deck. They have now cashed us SIX 2★'s on these pages TY after LW's dominating 41-20 win (-6') over Kansas St. They led 41-14 and had a 535-241 yd edge before KSt last 2 garbage time drives of 72 & 97 yds. They are now 8-1 ATS on the year and are outscoring their foes by 25 ppg. On the other side, we used KU as our NC Sportsline Complimentary Underdog POW (given out FREE every Tue on button #3 by calling 1-347-677-1700, 16-6, 73% since LY w/15 OUTRIGHT upsets!!!). We liked it so much that we made it a 4★ LPS as they easily dispatched Iowa St 34-14 (+3). Our insider sources tell us that they maybe leaning w/keeping interim HC Bowen (3-1-1 ATS w/him at helm). While this is the home finale for KU and not the greatest of situations for the Frogs, they now have limited opportunities left to impress the selection committee and need style pts and blowout wins w/3 unranked foes left and no B12 Title gm.

BYU by 24 over Univ - BYU has won 6 str (15-3 all-time) by 32 ppg, incl a 55-7 win (-18) in the L/gm ('10). After 6 str non-covers that also saw them lose 4 str gms outright, the Cougars got a much-needed win in their L/gm a 27-7 (-3) victory at MT. They come in off a bye, which was needed considering they lost RB Williams for the yr in their L/gm and now are playing the rest of the ssn w/out their 2 best offensive players (QB Hill OFY L/month). On the other side, a year after a rare bowl appearance, it's back to normal in Vegas as the Rebs are now 2-8 SU/3-7 ATS after we easily cashed a 3★ LPS going against them in their 48-21 loss (+5). Nov is usually a time to start backing the Cougars as in the L/5 yrs when not facing Utah or a Power 5 conf team, they are 10-1 SU/9-2 ATS and have won by an avg of 34 ppg in those wins. A win here assures them a spot in the Miami Beach Bowl and they only have lowly Savannah St on deck.

STANFORD by 9 over Utah - This is a legitimate revenge game and a good spot for the Cardinal. They are fresh off a bye and Utah's playing their 3rd AG in 5 wks and are off a brutal stretch winning in 2 OT's at Oreg St, beating USC in the last seconds, losing to Ariz St in OT and they had a misleading loss to Oregon LW (Oreg 100-yd FR td and only led 30-27 4Q). LY, in their only meeting, SU came in #5 and unbeaten on the road. It was Utah that out-muscled them and had a 301-199 yd edge at the half. Utah led 27-14 but SU got a td w/9:22 left then went 88/13 and on 4&2 from the 6 fired into the EZ inc. Utah's strong rush D held SU to 143 yds rush in the 27-21 win (+7'). While the Cardinal are just 5-4 overall TY, they still have a Top 5 D and at home TY, they are outscoring their foes by 23 ppg (+221 ypg!). Meanwhile Utah is -91 ypg on the road TY despite their 4-0 ATS mark. The Cardinal need a win here badly and look for them to take adv of a Utah D that is starting to get gassed as they have all'd 269 and 239 rush yds the L/2 wks after all'g 113 ypg the first 7 gms.

UTAH ST by 20 over New Mexico - NM comes in 3-2 SU/2-3 ATS in this series but LY was their first meeting in 11 yrs. In '03 NM had beaten Utah St at home 34-7 (-14). My how times have changed. LY NM was +11 at home and were drilled 45-10. NM came into the matchup #2 in the country in ypg rush (349) but US held them to 158. HC Wells "I think we're solid vs the run, we're stingy, we know how to play gap control, we've got good players." Fast forward to TY and not much has changed, the Aggies lost QB Keeton early in the year and then lost their other 2 bkps. They haven't missed a beat thanks to a stout D all'g just 14 ppg in and 99 rush ypg (2.7) in conf play. They are 7-3 SU and have covered 5 of their L/6 gms incl a 20-3 win (-7) over Wyoming L/Fri. We used the Lobos as our top weekly LPS LW and they were ahead of the spread from start to finish in a 60-49 (+19) loss to Boise St. They actually led 49-41 in the 4Q and Boise scored a td w/less than a min left for a misleading final as the two tms combined for 1,301 yds. While NM is 7-2 ATS as an AD incl 3-0 TY w/2 outright upsets, Utah St is 15-5 ATS in conf play and we wonder if Boise's late comeback took the wind out of the Lobos' sails for the rest of the yr.

BOISE ST by 14 over San Diego St - These 2 schools have just 3 recent meetings. SDSt is 2-1 SU/3-0 ATS & has pulled off outright upsets the L2Y to become the 1st tm s/Wazzu in 2000-'01 to beat Boise in B2B ssn. LY's contest featured 6 lead changes & 4 ties. After Boise hit a fg in OT, the Aztecs needed 5 plays to score the GW td & won 34-31 (+6). We easily cashed our top weekly college 4★ side LPS going against the Broncos in their 60-49 (-19) win over NM. Boise was down by 14 on 3 separate occasions in the 1H & didn't take their 1st lead until 7:00 remained 4Q. The 2 tms comb'd for 1,301 yds of offense & Boise all'd 505 on the ground (although 417 of that was in the 1H as they made adjustments). We cashed a 3★ LPS totals play on the UNDER in SDSt's 35-21 win vs ID. Boise has won 17 of their L/18 at home SU (lone loss was to SDSt) & they are 3-1 ATS as a HF TY while SDSt is 1-3 TY as an AD. The Broncos are +133 ypg & +8 ppg vs our #63 sked while the Aztecs are +47 ypg & +3 ppg vs our #102 sked. BS needs to keep winning to remain in 1st place in the Mountain Div and we'll call for them by 2 td's here.

Oklahoma at TEXAS TECH - OU is on a 12-5 SU/11-6 ATS run in this series, but the HT is on an 8-2 SU/6-4 ATS run. LY TT was #10 while OU came in at #17. OU led 21-7 in the 3Q but TT took a 24-21 lead before the Sooners prevailed 38-30 (-6'). LW OU had a 14-3 2Q lead on BU, but then all'd 45 unanswered & lost 48-14 (-4) as they all'd ssn highs of 544 td & 396 pass yds while being held to 176 yds under their ssn avg. This is their 2nd AG in 3 wks while TT is fresh off a bye. The Sooners are on an 8-4 run as an AF incl 3-1 TY. This is the Red Raiders home finale & they lost 3 str ATS in that role & are on a 2-11-1 ATS run in the reg ssn, but they have won 9 of their L/13 as a HD. TT will miss out on a bowl for just the 2nd time in 14Y w/a loss here as Stoops is 18-7 ATS off a SU loss. However, w/both QB's? As of presstime, we'll pass on this one for now.

ARKANSAS by 2 over Lsu - Nice sked edge here for Ark as they're off a bye while LSU is off another physical & emotional gm vs Bama. LSU has won 4 of the L/5 SU incl 3 str but Ark is on a 6-1 ATS run & the HT has won 5 of 6 (4-2 ATS). LY LSU won 31-27 (-26) after a 49 yd GW td pass by backup QB Jennings (Mettenberger inj'd) capped off a 99/8pl drive. LW after a late Bama TO all'd the Tigers (+6') to take the lead w/50 left, their ensuing KO went OOB & Bama drove 55 yds to kick the gm tying 27 yd FG w/0:03 left, sending the gm into OT where the Tide would win 20-13. The Hogs are 7-2 ATS TY with 5 matchups vs Top 10 ranked foes. They have been close to snapping what has now become a 17 gm SEC losing streak as they lost in OT to A&M, lost by 1 vs Bama & lost by 7 at top ranked MSU. Can they take advantage of an LSU tm that put forth a total effort LW? We'll say Woo Pig Sowie!

ARIZONA by 14 over Washington - The visitor had been on a 4-0 SU/ATS run from 2005-'08, but now the HT is a perfect 6-0 SU/ATS. LY down 5 w/5:14 left 3Q, UA was SOD at the UW41, int'd at the UW37, SOD at their own 37 & time exp'd at the 50 on their L/4 pass in their 31-13 (+9) loss. After having their playoff bubble burst 2 wks ago, the Wildcats capitalized on 4 CU TO's, converting each into TD's during their 38-20 (-16) homecoming win. UW was down 31-10 at HT at home to UCLA & went on to lose 44-30 (+6'). It was the 3rd time in 10 gms that the Huskies all'd 40+ pts TY under HC Peterson, who all'd that many pts just 4X in 105 gms as HC of Boise. UW's last 3 trips here have been brutal losing by 34, 30 and 35. Arizona is +67 ypg & +11 ppg vs our #16 sked while UW is -51 ypg & +4 ppg vs our #46 sked. Wildcats are in must win mode to stay alive in the P12 South race while Wash has some depth/injury issues. **Way back in 1982 and 1983, we had College 5★ GOY winners on Arizona over a team from the state of Washington, will we turn back the clocks here?**

GEORGIA by 1 over Auburn - This is the Deep Douth's oldest rivalry (ply'd every yr s/1892). Coming into LY each had won 54 gms and the 2 have tied 8 times although UGA has won 6 of the L/8 SU (5-3 ATS). This rivalry used to be dominated by the visitor but the HT is on a 5-2 SU/ATS run. UGA was very banged up for LY's game & they trailed 37-17 w/12:39 left but took the lead w/1:49 left. Aub got a 74 yd td pass off a deflection with 1:24 left to pull out the win with UGA being stopped at the Aub25 at the end. UGA rebounded from their deflating loss to UF with a 63-31 (-10) route of KY as they had a 559-353 yd edge & Isaiah McKenzie became just the 5th FBS pl'r s/'04 to have a KR & PR td in the same gm. AU saw its playoff chances disappear as they were shocked 41-38 (-21) at home to A&M despite 31-22 FD & 582-453 yd edges (fumbled at A&M 1-yd line late and A&M had a blk'd FG ret TD on late play of 1H). It was HC Malzahn's 1st home loss. AU has dropped 3 str in Athens by 23 ppg and this is the Bulldogs 1st HG in 42 years. They will get the all-important return of RB Gurley from susp and we look for this one to go down to the wire.

FLORIDA by 3 over South Carolina - Florida had won 17 of 18 meetings from 1992-'09 but SC has won 3 of the L/4. The Gators are 13-1 all time in Gainesville in this series. LY UF would lose its 5th str gm of the season, their longest losing streak s/'79 as they had a banged up team and st'd Skyler Mornhinweg at QB, who was taking his first snaps all year (10-13-107). SC trailed the majority of the game but took the lead on a 34 yd fg with 6:43 left in their 19-14 win (-13'). After an embarrassing 42-13 loss on HC, the Gators have now won B2B gms & are off a 34-10 (-14) win at Vandy in which they had a 429-308 yd edge & forced 4 TO's. SC comes in off a much needed bye as they've dropped 4 str SEC gms. The HT has won 3 in a row SU and is on a 10-5 ATS run. UF is on a 4-10 run as a HF with 3 str ATS losses as a SEC HF incl being outright upset twice. SC is on a 16-10-1 run as an AD incl 1-0 TY. A Gator win makes them bowl eligible after missing the postssn for the 1st time s/1990 LY. We'll call for them to get the close win here, but SC and Spurrier are dangerous here and will pull out all the stops (see Aub gm earlier TY).

ULM +7' over Louisiana

ULM was 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS from '02-'07 but UL then won the next 5 str (4-1 ATS). LY ULM pulled the outright upset as a 14' pt dog on the road, 31-21. UL QB Broadway was inj'd in the 1H. This series has been easy to handicap. Take the visitor and call for the outright upset. In the series between these two instate rivals the HT is 5-10 SU/2-13 ATS and amazingly in those 15 matchups, there have been 10 outright upsets (67% of the time). This yr however, the visiting Ragin' Cajuns are the fav (1st time s/08 in Monroe) & they've won 4 str here. UL became bowl eligible & remained undefeated in SBC play after their 44-16 win at NMSt. They're 2-4 as an AF under HC Hudspeth but this is their 1st time in that role TY. We upgraded a 2★ on these pages into a 3★ LPS play on ULM as they covered in their 31-29 (+4) loss at Appalachian St. They led the gm 20-7 in the 1H and also under 2 min left in the gm. The Warhawks find themselves as a HD for the 1st time this yr and while we won't lean with the visitor like recent series history, we will call for the 11th outright upset in the L/16 yrs.

NAVY by 3 over Georgia Southern - These schools have just one previous meeting which Navy won 13-7 (-30) in 2010. Both schools feature option based rush attacks as GS is avg 389 (7.3) rush ypg while Navy is avg 350 (6.2) rush ypg. The Midshipmen are fresh off a bye after their 49-39 (+14) loss vs ND and have a bye on deck while GS is on it's 3rd AG in 4 wks & is coming off a 28-25 (-14) win at TXSt. The Eagles were outFD'd 26-9 & outg'd 439-268 but had a 28-10 lead mid 4Q thanks to a 100 yd IR td on the final pl of the 3Q. This is Navy's home finale & they've won 11 str in that role by an avg of 21 ppg (3-1 ATS run), but they are on just a 11-17-1 run as a HF incl 1-3 TY. GS is 7-1 all time as an AD incl 2-0 TY. Against that same TXSt team that GS struggled with, Navy won by 14 & had a 27 yd edge (w/a bkp QB). The Midshipmen need to win 2 of their L/3 gms to become bowl elig for a 3rd str ssn & look for them to play inspired in front of their home fans.

MARSHALL by 20 over Rice - This is a revenge gm for Marshall as they lost to Rice in LY's CUSA title gm 41-24 (-6). The gm was pl'd at Rice due to tie-breaker rules despite the Herd receiving votes in both the Cch's & Harris polls. MU had won by an avg of 53-13 at home but only 36-30 on the road. Rice led 34-10 after 3Q's & finished with a 487-371 yd edge. The Herd remained 1 of 3 unbeaten FBS tms as after spotting SM a 14-0 lead before taking an offensive snap, they outscored them 63-3. MU is the only tm in the FBS to score 35+ pts in every gm this ssn. Rice is off a 17-7 (-10) home win vs UTSA to become bowl elig for a 3rd str ssn as they had 22-18 FD, 420-257 yd & 41:10-18:50 TOP edges. The Owls are on a 3-0-1 ATS run in the series, but the HT is on a 4-1 SU/3-1-1 ATS run. The Herd have won 12 str HG's SU (8-3-1 ATS) and are on an 8-1-1 run as a HF, while Rice is on a 7-2 run as an AD. The diff between these two tms is drastic TY. Against 3 common foes (ODU, FIU & SM) MU is 3-0 SU/ATS, +40 ppg & +199 ypg while Rice is 2-1 SU/ATS, +10 ppg & +69 ypg. MU gets revenge & gets closer to a major bowl bid.

NOTRE DAME by 11 over Northwestern - The Wildcats are 1-14 SU s/65 vs ND but that one win was LTH ('95, also L/gm), 17-15 (+28) as current NW HC Fitzgerald was an AA LB at the time and the win sparked an improbable run to the Rose Bowl. NW becomes just the 3rd Big 10 tm s/96 to travel and play a Power 5 conf school on the road after the Big Ten schedule starts. LW the Irish had a 487-412 yd edge vs Ariz St but lost the gm by 24 pts! ASU got two long IR TD's and also got 13, 23 and 8-yd "drives" after ND TO's (35 pts on 49 yds of offense!). ND also threw an int in the Ariz St end zone and mishandled a snap on a short FG and still rallied from a 34-3 deficit to make it 34-31 w/under 5 min left (Ariz St 21 pts in L/4:29). Everett Golson while spectacular on many plays has become a TO machine w/17 in the L/6 gms and the ND D (2 more str on LW) has now given up a schl-rec 168 pts in the L/4 gms. On the other side, it's been a dreadful 2 yrs for NW fans after their 4-0 start LY as they are 4-13 since and are on a 4-14 ATS run. While they covered LW in a 10-9 loss (+2) to Michigan, it was more heartbreak as they were stopped on a 2 pt cony at the end (QB slipped). However, they have yet to be eliminated from bowl contention (only Purdue and Illinois left) and ND's abysmal 8-22 ATS mark as a DD fav vs Power 5 conf tms (0-2 TY) while also having a very leaky D has us backing the Cats here!

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 16 over Miami, Oh - These MAC rivals don't meet often but s/05 the visitor is 3-1 SU/ATS incl 2 outright upsets. CM has won 4 of the L/5 SU incl B2B & is on a 5-1 ATS run in this series. The last time CM won 3 str in this series was from 1988-'90. LY both came in winless & Miami had a 185-80 yd edge at HT but trailed 7-3 as the Chippewas got a 54 yd PR setting up a 19 yd td drive. The Redhaws took a 9-7 lead but CM went onto win 21-9 (-3). Both schools enter fresh off a bye & while the Chip's are bowl eligible, Miami was the 1st FBS tm to lose 7 gms TY. CM is on a 6-2 run as a HF (5-1 vs FBS) & 3-0 ATS off a bye the L3Y, but the Redhaws after going just 2-11 as an AD the L2Y coming into the ssn, are 4-1 in that role TY. Against 2 common foes the Chip's are 2-0 SU/ATS, +11 ppg & +141 ypg while Miami is 0-2 SU/1-1 ATS, -9 ppg & -174 ypg. CM's strength is in the trenches as they are avg 217 rush ypg & allg 69 rush ypg their L/5 gms while the Redhaws are avg just 87 rush ypg & are allg 246 rush ypg on the road TY.

Middle Tennessee by 3 over FIU - MT has won 4 of the L/5 SU/ATS in this series. The HT is 6-3 SU, but the visitor has won 3 of the L/4 ATS. FIU was embarrassed in LY's meeting losing 48-0 (+18) while getting outg'd 556-233. The Golden Panthers are off an emotional 38-35 (+3) loss at OD as they all'd 10 pts in the final 1:05 incl the GW 28 yd fg as time expired. This will be just the 2nd gm in nearly a month for MT who comes in fresh off a bye after losing to BYU at home 27-7 (+3) the week prior. This is FIU's home finale & they are on a 1-4 ATS run in that role & are on a 6-11 run as a HD. The Blue Raiders are on a 8-2 ATS run off a SU loss incl 3-0 TY & are on a 12-6 run as an AF. MT is 1 win away from becoming bowl elig for a 3rd str ssn and we'll call for them to get it here.

SAN JOSE ST by 10 over Hawaii - Hawaii had been 9-1 SU in this series from '00-'10, but SJSt has won the L/2 SU/ATS. Surprisingly the home team is just 3-5 SU in this series, 4-4 ATS. LY was their 1st MW meeting. SJSt was w/o their top 2 rec but led 27-14 at HT & went onto win 37-27 (-4). The Spartans are off a 38-24 (+2) loss to FSU as we cashed a 3★ on these pages going against them. After taking an early 14-7 lead, SJSt all'd 28 str pts. This will be UH's 2nd str gm on the mainland & they are off a 49-22 (+20) loss at CSU. The Rainbow Warriors are on a 1-7 ATS run overall, 6-9 run as an AD, incl 0-3 TY & are just 1-4 ATS the L3Y in their 2nd str AG (no byes). This is the Spartans home finale where they are on a 3-0 SU/4-0 ATS run in that role & they're 2-0 as a HF TY (both as DD HF). Against their 3 common foes UH is 1-2 SU/ATS, -8 ppg & -54 ypg while SJSt is 1-2 SU/ATS, -3 ppg & +158 ypg. The Spartans have to win out to become bowl eligible and they'll take a first step here w/a DD win.

IDAHO By 7 over Troy - These schools have met just once with Troy winning at home 47-7 (-24) in 2004. The Trojans picked up their 2nd win of the ssn LW after beating the SBC's worst tm GSt 45-21 (-7). Troy forced 3 TO's as they snapped their 3 gm losing streak but only had a 440-394 yd edge. We cashed a 3★ LPS on the UNDER as ID fell on the road to SDSt 35-21 (+20) despite a 26-18 FD edge. The Vandals were down 28-21 mid-4Q (fumbled at SDSt 14) before all'g a final td w/5:32 left. ID has now covered 5 str gms, but are just on a 5-11 run as a HF & this is their home finale where they are on just a 1-8 SU/2-6 ATS run. The Trojans, however are just 1-3-1 as an AD TY & are just 4-10 ATS off a SU win. We'll back the home town Vandals to cover their 6th straight here as LW's misleading finals gives us some value

TEXAS A&M By 1 over Missouri - MO has won 4 of the L/5 meetings SU & is on a 3-1 ATS run in this series. LY A&M came into MO #19 with MO needing a win to wrap up the SEC Title game at #5. A&M led 14-7 at HT & HC Pinkel had been just 11-44 when trailing at the half. Henry Josey broke off a 57 yd GW td run with 3:34 left to lift MO to a 28-21 (-4) win. A&M is off perhaps the upset of the year as they essentially eliminated Auburn from the playoffs with a stunning 41-38 (+21) road win. The key play happened just before HT when A&M blk'd a fg & ret'd it 65 yds for a td to take a 35-17 lead. The Tigers enter off a bye after a 3 gm winning streak. The Tigers are -49 ypg in SEC play while A&M is -32 ypg. Keep in mind, before the upset over Auburn, A&M had failed to cover 5 str gms. Mizzou is comfortable in their AD role as they are 9-3 ATS and have already pulled 2 outright upsets on SEC road earlier TY (SC and UF). Can they make it 3 for 3?

Memphis by 11 over TULANE - Homecoming in New Orleans. UM has dominated this series winning 7 in a row SU/ATS s/03 by an avg of 22 ppg. Their last series loss was in 2000. The Tigers are off an emotional 16-13 (-7) win at Temple last Friday to become bowl eligible for the 1st time s/08 & remain in the hunt for an AAC Title. PK Elliot kicked the GW 31 yd fg w/no time left. TU pulled off a major upset by going to Houston & winning 31-24 (+17) despite being outFD'd & outgained as they benefited from 4 Cougar TO's. This will be the 3rd AG in 4 wks incl B2B for the Tigers & they are on a 2-7-1 run as an AF. The Green Wave under HC Johnson are 8-2 as a HD, but are 0-2 in that role TY. These tms have pl'd 3 common foes (all AAC) with UM going 2-1 SU/1-2 ATS, +14 ppg & +96 ypg while TU is 1-2 SU/ATS, -8 ppg & -80 ypg. Look for UM to continue their run to a possible AAC title.

Arizona St by 3 over OREGON ST - As you would expect with the 2 diverse climates, the HT is 12-2 SU, but the visitor is on a 5-1 ATS run. LY ASU moved to 19-1 SU at home vs OSU with a 30-17 win (-14). The dog in this series has covered 5 of the L/6 Y. ASU kept its playoff hopes alive after holding off a late rally to beat ND 55-31 (-1) as we easily cashed our 3★ LPS on the OVER. Up 34-3 late 2Q, they all'd ND to pull within 3 mid 4Q, but then scored the final 21 pts. 35 of their pts came off 5 Irish TO's incl 2 long IR TD's and three short TD drives and in our opinion, it was the biggest misleading game of the week. OSU is in their 3rd str HG & is off a disappointing 39-32 (-7) loss vs WSU. They were outFD'd 33-23 & all'd 506 tt yds. While we are not happy w/what we have seen from Oreg ST as of late, how much can the overrated Sun Devils have left in the tank after a grueling 4 wk stretch?

ALABAMA by 7 over Miss St - In 1992, we used our 5★ College GOY on Miss St +11 vs a Bama tm that would go on to win the Nat'l Title and cashed. Not only SEC but also playoff implications will be on the line as this is the marquee matchup of the week in college football. Bama has won 6 str by 22 ppg in this series with the closest MOV being LY's 13 pt victory. The #1 ranked Bulldogs are essentially off a bye as they beat FCS UT Martin 45-16 & have Vandy on deck. While MSU is on a 6-10 run as an AD, the L2Y they are 3-1 incl an outright upset in Death Valley earlier TY. The Crimson Tide survived Death Valley at night as they drove 50 yds in the final :50 to kick a fg which sent the gm into OT & won 20-13 (-6). QB Sims 44% completions was the lowest by a Bama QB in an SEC gm in the L5Y but he made the plays and the throws he had to do on their final 2 drives. Against 4 common foes (All SEC) the Bulldogs are 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS, +19 ppg & +125 ypg while Bama is 4-0 SU/2-2 ATS, +26 ppg & +166 ypg. While we think the Crimson Tide are clearly the better tm here, seeing an undefeated #1 team as a td dog makes us a little leery. We'll call this one at the number for now and also note that the series has seen the total go UNDER in 7 str gms.

Texas by 3 over OKLAHOMA ST - Texas has owned this series going 23-5 SU, but OSU has won 3 of the L/4 SU/ATS. The visitor has won 5 in a row SU & 6 str ATS in this series and UT has won 7 str trips to Stillwater by 19 ppg. LTH there were 4 lead changes in the 4Q and UT got a controversial GW td w/29 left in the 41-36 (-2) win. LY OSU rolled to a 28-10 HT lead and won 38-13 (-3). The Pokes are fresh off a much needed bye as after starting the ssn 5-1, they've now lost 3 str (4 str ATS) & they are in must win mode to reach a bowl because they have road trips to BU & OU to close out the ssn. This is their home finale and they are on a 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS run vs tms other than OU in that role. The Longhorns are 1 win away from becoming bowl eligible after their 33-16 (+4) homecoming win over WV which gave them B2B wins for the 1st time TY. They kept WV out of the EZ until the 4Q as we cashed a 3★ LPS on the UNDER. UT is 4-1 ATS away from Austin TY. Horns make it 3 wins in a row to become bowl eligible in HC Strongs 1st ssn.

Michigan St by 10 over MARYLAND - These new B10 rivals last met in 1950 & MSU's only visit to College Park was in 1944. The Spartans have won 4 of 5 overall meetings. MD enters fresh off a bye and pulled the outright upset over PSU 20-19 (+3) the week prior. The pre-game antics by the MD captains and a shove by WR Diggs will see him susp'd for this gm. MSU likely saw it's B10 Champ dreams & definitely saw it's playoff dreams disappear after their 49-37 loss to OSU. The loss snapped their 14 gm B10 winning streak & the 568 ttl yds incl 268 rush yds all'd were ssn highs. The Spartans are on a 15-4-1 run as an AF incl 10-2 s/10. The Terrapins are on a 3-6 run as a HD & are on a 1-7 ATS run off a reg ssn bye. After seeing their bubble burst how will Sparty respond?

Tuesday, November 18th

Massachusetts at AKRON - In '12 UMass got their lone win of the year as they were +16' at AU and despite being outgained 427-327, they pulled off the upset 22-14. UA was playing with legit revenge on the road LY and was -7. UMass actually led 13-7 after 3Q's but UA got a 17 yd td pass to lead 14-13 w/9:49 left and won. The Minutemen come in off a HG vs Ball St as they had covered 5 str gms prior while Akron is off a road trip to Buffalo and they had failed to cover 4 straight prior. LW's gms are unknown at presstime and while UMass has the tech edges, the Zips could be going for bowl eligibility here.

Northern Illinois at OHIO - The L/gm came in the '11 MAC Title. OU led 20-0 at HT but all'd 10 pts in L/2:52 incl a GW 33 yd fg as time exp'd. Big situational edge to the Bobcats who are coming off a bye while NIU just played UT LW and have surprising MAC West contender WM on deck. The Bobcats are 10-4 ATS as a HD under Solich w/4 str outright upsets but NIU counters w/a 10-3 ATS mark as an AF and have won 13 straight AG's in MAC play.

4★ Pittsburgh by 14 over TENNESSEE - We're getting some line value here as both teams travelled are off bad road losses. While TEN was beaten by 14 it was to a 5 win BAL team while the Steelers lost by a TD to a one wins Jets squad. A deeper look shows that PIT had a 362-275 yd edge while TEN was outgained 312-210 and didn't have a play over 20 yards. PIT DC Dick Lebeau is 18-2 SU vs rookie QB's covering both matchups LY holding the Jets to 267 yds and BUF to 227 yds. Expect Titans QB Mettenberger to be a bit gun shy as he was sacked 5 times and was hit an additional 8 times LW while the Steelers had 4 sacks and 7 QBH vs a much more mobile Vick. TEN has been outgained in every home game by 68 ypg and has had 14, 14, 13, 14 FD's their last 4 overall and without any rush attack (62 ypg, 3.1) during that span even Warren Moon would struggle. Steelers have already gone 3-0 SU/ATS TY off a loss TY and after giving LW's opponent their second win they won't give another bottom feeder their 3rd.

3★ KANSAS CITY by 7 over Seattle - This is the Seahawks only road game in a 4 week span but they have ARZ on deck. SEA's only road cover TY came against WAS who still managed 3 drives of 70+ yds against them with Cousins at the helm. LY the Seahawks earned a 69.1 defensive QBR on the road with just a 8-12 ratio with 24 sacks. TY they are giving up a 107.8 QBR with a 7-1 ratio and just 5 sacks in 4 road games. KC has only turned the ball over twice in the LW, Smith has a 98.5 QBR in that span and the Chiefs have been very effective on the ground with 134 ypg (4.4). SEA is used to having the crowd noise edge but the Arrowhead fans will be on Wilson who's thrown for less than 200 yds in 3 of 4 road games TY. Wilson has outrushed Lynch on the road 70 ypg (10.8) to 56 (4.1) and while KC is giving up 115 ypg rush (4.5) at home they are 3rd in sacks by SEA. SEA did set a franchise record for rushing yards but Wilson had a poor game (53.7 QBR), the Giants hung with them for 3 Qtrs despite a tough travel situation and the Chiefs aren't intimidated covering vs DEN, NE, and SD. We'll side with home team that's covered 4 straight with a manageable line vs a SEA team that's who's only cover in the L5W is vs the Giants crossing cross-country off MNF.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ CLEVELAND by 6 over Houston - This is the battle of ex-Tom Brady backup QB's. This is a plus matchup for CLE as home teams off a Thur Nite road win are 13-1 ATS with a 29-12 avg score (+86 ypg). This is Mallett's first career start (28 NFL snaps) with CLE rebuilding their home edge going 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS with the loss against BAL who won on a 32 yd FG as time expired. HOU only has two real receiving targets in Johnson/Hopkins (63% rec yds) and CLE was allowing a 65.2 QBR in their 4 games prior to mauling Dalton (2.0). Hoyer's 59% comp rate is misleading as he has 39 att's of 20+ yds (top 5 all year) and in 4 of his L5 games he's logged a ypa of 8.6 or more (Rodgers #1 8.4 ypa). The system is designed for him to throw the ball away vs taking sacks (1 every 21 att's) or Ints (4) much like Alex Smith. CLE expects WR Hawkins (high) and TE Cameron (concussion) to return and while we respect the threat of Foster here HOU has the #29 pass defense (10-4 ratio 98.9 QBR) and we'll take the home team alone in first place for the 1st time since Sept 1995.

OTHER GAMES

Buffalo at Miami - Thurs. In Wk#2 BUF beat MIA 29-10 and was +3 TO's but despite being in the redzone 7 times they scored an offensive TD only once and were held to 13 FD's. The Dolphins D at home has held NE, KC, GB and SD to an avg of 301 ypg but in QB Orton's 2 road starts he played at the #1 D of DET and #6 D of the Jets and beat both. Grab this Marquee on Thursday after Noon ET.

CHICAGO by 4 over Minnesota - The Vikings are 0-4 SU/ATS off a bye scoring 10 or less in 3 straight. They did cover 3 straight prior to the bye despite a struggling OL that has allowed 30 sacks (#29). Bridgewater has slowly improved over his L4 games more than doubling his QBR from 41.3 vs DET to 88.2 vs WAS but he hasn't hit 7.0 ypa in that stretch with a 3-5 ratio. That's a concern as while CHI has the #27 pass defense their issues are in giving up explosive plays which MIN doesn't really do at this point. Zimmer's done his magic on defense which has 30 sacks and helped cover up their secondary issues (92.7 QBR). CHI is only outgaining foes by 12 ypg at home and are -7 TO's despite the slew of talent at the skill positions. While better at defending the run vs LY (51 ypg improvement) they can't get off the field allowing 43% on 3rd Dns (22nd). Without knowing the SNF results vs GB and seeing if Trestrman has adjusted the offense to cut down on Cutler's gunslinger style we'll call for the Bears by 4 and wait for the line.

Philadelphia at GREEN BAY - Both teams are off LW's primetime events and while PHI beat GB 27-13 at Lambeau LY Foles isn't rushing and GB won't be forced to play their 3rd string QB off the bench. PHI had a 204 (5.5) to 99 (3.3) rush edge as GB's injury depleted defense couldn't hold up. After coming off a plus matchup vs CAR at home on MNF vs the #25 defense for Sanchez is a different deal now. GB's defense is better than their #26 ranking and at home they are holding foes 104 ypg less than on the road with a 50 ypg improvement vs the run w/a 37-17 avg score. Rodgers is shredding NDIV foes to the tune of 296 ypg (66%) with a 11-3 ratio and PHI gave up 329 yds and 2 TD's to Palmer with ARZ being just the 2nd team with a winning record right now PHI has faced (1-1 ATS). We really need to see how Sanchez fared in his 1st start in 2 years vs CAR before making a reliable forecast here.

CAROLINA by 3 over Atlanta - The home team has covered 3 straight, CAR is 6-2 ATS at home vs a Div foe and Div HF's off a MNF game are 10-3-1 ATS. The Falcons are a self-cid FG vs DET away from being in 1st place for the NFC South but 67% of their wins have been vs TB. They've been outgained in 4 straight games, allowed TB to convert 12 3rd Dns and are giving up 418 ypg on the road (27th). To his credit Ryan has been the stabilizer for ATL (93.6 QBR) with an OL that just had the same 5 starters for the 3rd straight game for the 1st time TY. Newton's has done fairly well vs ATL with 225 ypg (62%) 7-3 in his L4 games adding 74 ypg (8.5) rushing on avg. This isn't LY's CAR defense (20 sacks in 9 games vs 60 for 2013) but they'll have a better home crowd than TB did as a good portion were ATL fans. Minus the TB games ATL has only earned 5 sacks and are allowing 138 ypg (4.1) rushing with just 4 Ints made. ATL is -35 ypg vs the #23 sked while CAR is -57 vs the #8 sked. Beating the Bucs who are playing OAK level ball TY is one thing but without seeing how the Panthers fared on MNF with extra time to prep we'll call for the home team by a FG.

NEW ORLEANS by 10 over Cincinnati - Things go from bad to worse for CIN (1-4-1 ATS since bye) as after imploding vs CLE they travel to NO who are off a loss and in a foul mood with their 20 game home win streak under Payton snapped. CIN is allowing 158 ypg (4.4) rush since their bye with just 6 sacks giving up 29.7 ppg. They are earning 115 ypg (4.6) rushing allowing 12 sacks with 19.5 ppg with -6 TO's. CIN gave up over 500 yds each to Brady and Luck with QBR's of 110.7 and 105.7 and now faces Brees who has 8 games over those marks the L2Y at home. Teams that lost SU as a Thursday Nite fav are 1-7 ATS and NO is 17-4-1 ATS at home off a loss. They weren't outplayed by SF but Brees' 2 Ints were turned into 7 pts ended a drive at the SF 22 before the half. He now gets the #30 defense on the road that hasn't allowed less than 23 pts in 6 straight games. Ingram ran the ball effectively for the 3rd straight game (131 ypg 4.8) and NO is +69 ypg (3rd) TY with CIN being -52 ypg (#26). While both QB's have consistency issues the Saints are more reliable and at home with a manageable line making them the play.

WASHINGTON by 4 over Tampa Bay - TB went back to McCown LW and while the Bucs converted more 3rd Dns (12) than they did in the previous 4 games (10) combined. The Bucs moved the ball well for the 2nd week in a row but 3 TO's with one ending a 76 yd drive on the ATL 4 in the 4th Qtr crippled them. TB's OL is simply poor as they cant run the ball with their 6th game in L7 under 100 yds (73 ypg 3.6) and 16 sacks in the L4 games. WAS is 1-5 ATS after a bye and their #10 Def ranking

is false as their 16 giveaways has them defending short fields. They've been without 3 key defensive starters (LB Orakpo, CB Hall, NT Coffield) for most of the year and are working with a rookie CB and 1st year starter at MLB earning a 101.8 defensive QBR (#31 18-3 ratio). They gave up 4 TD's on 5 drives in the middle of the MIN game and are 6-12-1 hosting a NDIV foe. Griffin's mobility is a plus especially vs a limited TB defense but the Bucs are desperate, Nov home teams off a bye are 6-12-1 ATS and we'll call for the home team by a FG in a higher scoring game.

Denver by 7 over ST LOUIS - This is a letdown spot for DEN with their 3rd straight road game after losing to NE, blowing out OAK with a home game vs playoff contender MIA on deck. STL followed up their win vs SF with a solid effort vs ARZ but the Cardinals QB change threw their defense out of sync. LW was the first time all year the Rams had both starting CB's together and they did a good job of limiting Palmer (241 yds 69% but 6.7 ypa) for the most part. Keep in mind Fisher's experience vs Manning while at TEN and his defense has finally been getting in sync with 11 sks, 18 QBH and 16 Int's vs SF/ARZ. STL hasn't faced a quality passer since Romo allowing 217 yds (78%) 2-1 though and DEN has outgained NDIV foes by 99 yds with an 18-5 ratio (106.2 QBR). STL gave up 2 TD's on TO's in the 4th Qtr to inflate the score vs ARZ. We'll call for the Broncos by 7 as the line will top double digits and Fisher will keep his defense from being intimidated by the Broncos offense.

San Francisco by 7 over NY GIANTS - The Giants only have a slight situational edge here as they travelled back from the Pacific Northwest wondering what happened having played with the Seahawks for 3 Qtrs. They gave up 26 more rushing yards (350) than what they had in total offense and now face the #10 rush offense. Yes, Manning completed 66% vs the #9 pass defense but he only had a 6.4 ypa with the 2nd longest completion being 25 yds. Outside of Beckham (108 yds 15.4 LW) the Giants lack the ability to push the ball downfield or get yards after the catch. The Giants are only 0-5 SU/1-4 ATS as a HD and SF has a full game of how the Giants adjusted after losing #1 CB Amakamura. SF did go deep into OT LW but road teams off a road OT win are 12-3-1 ATS. SF has also ran a variation of the WCO that the Giants are still adjusting to and will finally get Aldon Smith back to reinforce a #26 pass rush that needs him. SF is 10th with +37 ypg (+6 TO's) while the Giants are 29th with -61 ypg (-6 TO's) off an embarrassing loss. We'll call for the road team by 2 FG's in a higher scoring game.

SAN DIEGO by 7 over Oakland - OAK is 6-3 ATS vs SD and teams that were shutout prior to their bye are 2-5 ATS. SD is 1-5 ATS off a bye and they've lost 3 straight after being touted as a team that could challenge DEN in the AFC West. SD has outgained foes by 88 ypg (+3 TO's) at home TY with their only loss coming vs KC who had a bye week to prep for them. SD gave up 396 yds to OAK only winning by 3 as a 7 pt AF the Raiders changed coaches during their bye and how Carr operated as they set a season high in rush yards (52 yds over avg), 2nd most passing yards and season high in points. After avg 60 ypg rush (3.6) in 3 games prior to the bye SD does get RB Mathews (1,255 4.4 LY) back after missing 7 straight with a knee sprain. SD doesn't have much of a pass rush (15 sks #26) and after LW's debacle vs DEN the line value shifts to the Raiders here. OAK is a desperate team and with a line of this size and home team off a bye being 10-17-1 ATS the threat of a backdoor cover has us calling for SD by a TD here.

Detroit by 3 over ARIZONA - The Cardinals have their best record since 1948 but it came at a steep price with Palmer (ACL) likely being out the rest of the year. ARZ didn't pull away from the Rams until his injury with the defense scoring 2 TD's in the 4th Qtr where the Cardinals have outscored foes 91-34. ARZ is used to the adversity having been in this situation before and Arians isn't concerned about altering the playbook for Stanton although he only has a 49% comp rate with 6.6 ypa thus far. DET was operating at full strength for the 1st time since the Jets offensively (Bush, Pettigrew, Megatron) and it showed as they outgained a tough Dolphins team 351-222. While ARZ is holding foes to 79 ypg (3.4) rushing that doesn't bother DET as they are a pass first team. Peterson vs Megatron will grab the headlines but keep in mind Tate has faced this defense with SEA (34 and 77 rec yds LY) with a run 1st scheme. This battle has potential playoff implications in terms of tie breakers and we'll side with the healthier and better rested road team with the #1 defense getting points here.

New England at Indianapolis - Only 2nd home game for the Colts in the last 6 weeks and Luck has enjoyed the prime time lights with an 18-4 record. Meanwhile IND is 2-0 SU/ATS off a bye under HC Pagano while the Pat's have surprisingly failed to cover their last 3. It will be a great Sunday Night matchup but with both teams off bye do the potent offenses come out rusty?
