4★ Ohio St over PENN ST - OSU is 9-3 SU/8-4 ATS in this series & the visitor is 5-2 SU/ATS OSU has won the L3 here by an avg of 16 ppg despite being -3', +5 and pick 'em. LTH OSU trailed 7-0 and the game was tied 7-7 at HT. An early 2H 17 yd IR td sparked OSU to score 21 of the next 24 pts to lead 28-10 into the 4Q. LY PSU all'd their most pts in 114 years (Duquesne, 64 1899) it was a rare night HG for the Bucks and OSU led 42-7 (409-168 yds at HT). It was 63-7 with 8:24 left & PSU got a 65 yd td pass w/7:33 to play. PSU is fresh off 2 byes the L3W and playing their biggest HG of the season thus far. OSU is off a dominating 56-17 (-22) homecoming win over Rutgers, easily cashing a 4★ LPS as well as a 3★ on these pages for us. The Buckeyes have scored 50+ pts in 4 str gms for the 1st time in their 125 yr history! You also have to wonder how MD is going to hold up as they have had to deal with multiple inj's yet again and after facing a physical lowa tm, they now face a fresh Wisky team that needs to make a B10 statement as they have been the forgotten tm in their div after getting upset by NW a few wks back. 3★ Mississippi over LSU - ESPN's College Gameday will be on site & LSU is playing w/ legitimate revenge & its Homecoming. Over the L12Y, it's no surprise that LSU is 9-3 SU in this series, but what should surprise you is that LSU is 3-3 SU the L6Y & UM is 10-3 ATS incl LY's home upset win over #6 LSU and there was nothing fluky as UM had a 525-388 yd edge. The visitor is on a 12-3 ATS run. LTH ('12) UM almost got the upset losing 41-35 (+19). UM led 35-28 but all'd a 89 yd PR & 64/9pl td drive w/:15 left. LSU is playing for a 9th str wk & is off a 41-3 (-10') route over UK becoming bowl elig for a schl rec 15th str ssn. UM is off a route of their own, 34-3 (-17) over Tenn as they held the Vol's to 0 rush yds, the 1st SEC tm to be held w/o any rush yds s/11 (Florida). The Rebels are off to their best start s/JFK was in the White House (1962). Four of the L/5 gms have been decided by 7 pts or less but Ole Miss in our opinion is the best tm in the country (6-0-1 ATS TY) and LSU has been dominated by Auburn and Miss St already FORECAST: Mississippi by 10 this year.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ TCU over Texas Tech - 57th meeting but they've met just 4x's since their SWC days. TT is 2-0 SU/ATS as B12 rivals. LTH ('12) TT was +1' and led 36-26 but needed 3OT for the win with TCU having a 516-389 yd edge. There were 9 lead changes, 4 ties & neither tm led by more than 10. LY TCU was -3. The officiating was widely questioned after the game as TCU even had a PR td called back for a fair catch signal, which was not the case. TT dominated the 1H with a 211-133 yd edge and led 10-0. 2★ Óld Dominion (+) over WKU - First meeting. We cashed our #2 Economy Club play going against WKU in théir 45-38 (-4') loss at FAU as they couldn't hang onto a 31-14 HT lead. They were outFD'd 29-23 & outg'd 619-402. ODU enters fresh off a bye after losing 42-35 (+3) at UTEP where they were outFD'd 23-16 & outg'd 486-357. They have 1 common foe in MT & both lost SU/ATS but both had the yd advantages with the Hilltoppers being +177 while the Monarchs were +136. WKU is on a 1-8 run as a HF (lost outright TY), while ODU has already pulled one upset TY on the CUSA road vs the defending champs. EC has won 10 str conf home gms by 24 ppg They come into this matchup 5-1 and ranked in the Top 20 but as they start to feel the pressure of qualifying for one of the major bowls, they have failed to cover each of their L/2 gms as DD favs incl the L/gm vs USF 28-17 (-17') as we cashed our NC Sports Complimentary College POW going against them 2 wks ago (the play that just misses out being a ★-rated play, given out FREE every Sat on Button #3 by calling 1-347-677-1700). Speaking of failing to cover and cashing plays against them, Conn is the only tm in the country to be winless ATS TY as in their L/gm we cashed a 4★ on Tulane. Do we continue to go against Conn here or will E Carolina lines continue to be inflated?

Miami, FI at VIRGINIA TECH - LY VT was +6 on the road but finished with commanding 26-12 FD and 549-352 yd edges in a gm played in a steady rain. We used VT as a 4★ LPS and they led 28-14 at the half with a 258-150 yd edge. VT was SOD at the UM3 with 1:57 left and UM gained 73 of their yds on a the final 8 plays. VT is now 8-3 SU and on a 10-3 ATS run in this series. However, the visitor is now 7-3 ATS with 5 outright upsets in the L10Y and Miami is 17-3 all-time on ESPN Thur Nights. Troy at SOUTH ALABAMA - Troy is now 2-0 SU in this new rivalry but the visitor has covered both LTH ('12) Troy had a 495-252 yd edge and won 31-10 (-7'). LY Troy (-3) appeared in control at home leading 24-7 in the 3Q. However, S Bama got a 65 yd td pass w/:48 left for their first lead but Troy drove 66/5 getting a td w/:07 left for the 34-33 (-3') win. We don't duck losses here at NC Sports and it's been one of the major reasons why we've been in business 32 years and counting. LW's 4★ Key Selection on Troy was one of the most embarrassing losses we've had as they were mauled 53-14. We assumed Troy would continue to play inspired for their outgoing HOF coach (hammered NMSt wk prior) and App St had come in 1-5 SU/ATS and lost to an FCS schl the wk prior. We were wrong. On the flip side, S Bama pulled out a 30-27 win (-20') over Georgia St as there were 5 lead changes in 2H. Will S Bama be able to cover a large spread vs an in-state rival (0-3 ATS as DD fav) or did Troy officially fold their tents LW?

USF at CINCINNATI - UC is 7-3 SÚ/8-2 ATS in the séries. There have been 6 outright upsets L8Y. LTH they played in frigid conditions and UC (-13') led 27-3 before USF got a td w/7:19 left for a 27-10 final. LY it was a tough loss for the Bearcats. They had 21-12 FD and 350-241 yd edges but lost 26-20 (-11'). USF had a blk'd fg they ret'd 75 yds for a td and got a 10 yd FR td. Bearcats are off a 41-3 win (-23') over SMU LW. They had a 508-276 yd edge. USF had their largest comeback in schl history as down 27-7 at HT, they outscored Tulsa 31-3 in the 2H for a 38-30 win. Taggart is now 17-4 ATS in his career as an AD (6-1 here) but Cincy does have a

massive offensive edge (#39-118).

Byu at BOISE ST - Boise was 3-0 SU in this series winning 50-12 (-8') in '03, but then had a couple of 1 pt wins in '04 and '12 (-22 and -6'). LY BYU was at home and Boise gave QB Hedrick his first start. BYU led 24-3 at the half with a 376-202 yd edge. Boise was SOD a couple times in the 1H which Mendenhall called huge. BYU won 37-20 (-7). These two tms look to be going in opposite directions as Boise has gone 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS since their opening loss to what is now considered arguably the best tm in the country in Ole Miss while BYU has now lost 3 str gms and have failed to cover 5 str. LW we had another outright upset Big Dog POW winner (given out FREE every Thur on Button #9 by calling 1-347-677-1700) on Nevada (+12) as they scored 29 unanswered at one pt in the gm to beat BYU 42-35. California vs Oregon - Levi's Stadium. San Francisco, CA. Cal had won 3 in a row SU & ATS from '06-'08 but since then the Ducks are 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS and in the L/3 gms despite being at least a 24 pt fav, they've covered all 3 and won by an avg of 52-16. LY the game was ply'd in heavy rain and there were 8 fmbl's. UO was held to 381 yds of offense (563, 575 prev 2Y). Cal QB Goff came in avg 435 ypg but hit just 3-6-11 and was replaced. The Ducks came away w/a 55-16 (-37) win. The Ducks are right back in the playoff mix after B2B wins as they do what they always do vs Wash, win and cover (11 str). QB Mariota is now avg 280 ypg (70%) w/a 19-0 ratio. On the flip side, Cal is off B2B losses and LW despite getting outgained 567-366, they had a? call go against them late in a 36-34 loss (+7) to UCLA. While the Ducks are clearly the better team, will there be some peeking ahead here w/Stanford on deck?

AUBURN by 21 over S Carolina - Tigers are 9-1-1, w/the only loss in 1933. In the L/gm ('11), AU won 16-13 (+10'). Down 13-9 AU went 57/12pl getting a 9 yd td pass w/1:38 left. LTH ('10) SC (+3) led 20-7 mid-2Q & 27-21 into the 4Q. SC all'd a td w/13:35 left and their L/3 poss ended in TO's. Aub comes in off a bye and in their L/gm fell to Miss St 38-23 (-2') thanks to 4 TO's. After covering 13 gms in a row, they are now 1-3 ATS, their L/4. Malzahn is 7-3 ATS as a HF and in their L/HF role we easily cashed a 4★ with them over LSU 41-7 (-7'). On the other side, SCar is 4-3 SU but just 1-6 ATS TY and have failed to cover their L/4 gms. LW they beat Furman 41-10 (-38) and had a 548-302 yd edge. DC Ward moved up to the pressbox to try and improve a struggling SC D but they still allowed 211 rush yds and are all'g 182 rush ypg (5.3) on the ssn which is not good news facing a high-powered Aub attack that is avg 262 rush ypg (5.6) and has also quietly avg'd 257 pass ypg TY in SEC play (just 170 in SEC play LY). Tigers get their 3rd blowout SÉC win at home TY.

Northern Illinois by 21 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - NIU is 12-1 SU in this series and are on a current 5-1 ATS run. In fact, since EM upset them in '07, NI has won by 37, 44, 68, 6, 42 and 39 pts. In NI's L4 trips to E Michigan, they've all'd a grand ttl of 10 pts w/2 shutouts while scoring 184 pts and overall the visitor is 11-2 ATS. LY NI (-32) led 38-3 at the half with a 384-138 yd edge. Surprisingly the 3Q opened with 4 str scoring drives to make it 52-13 and NI got a td w/13:43 left, 59-13. EM went 82/19 getting a td w/4:11 left and NI was SOD at the EM8. While this is their 1st AG in a month, Carey is 6-1 ATS as an AF and the Huskies have a bye on deck. Their QB Hare (11-1 ratio) is getting better each wk and finally got going on the ground LW (180 yds) in their 51-41 win (-13') over Miami, Oh. Now he will be facing a EM D all'g 221 rush ypg (5.4). On the other side, E Mich fell to UMass LW 36-14 (+14') as they failed to score on their L/7 possessions. They are -248 ypg (#127) vs the #89 sked but are 2-0 SU on their new "Gray" turf. However, it's tough going against series history here as we look for the Huskies to come away with another comfortable win

Mississippi St by 17 over KENTUCKY - MSt if fresh off a bye while UK is playing their 5th str wk and just faced a physical LSU tm LW. MSt has won 5 in a row SU in this series and the visitor is 5-2 SU/6-1 ATS with MSt having won 4 in a row at this site. In '12 they led 27-7 early 3Q and won 27-14 (-9'). LY MSt jumped out to leads of 14-0 and 21-7 but UK rallied and covered in a 28-22 loss (+11) on a Thur Night. MSt 447-325 yd edge. In the last 3 meetings, MSt is +137 ypg. The #1 Bulldogs come in undefeated and are on an overall 10-1 ATS run dating back to LY. HC Mullen is 8-3 ATS as an AF and QB Prescott is among the Heisman favorites w/2,045 total yds and 22 td's. LSU took Kentucky seriously LW in their 41-3 beatdown (-10') and we expect Miss St will do the same. We also expect them to travel well here as their fan base should be excited playing as the #1 team in the country for the first time in schl history. Also keep in mind, while KY did pull off a home upset over SC earlier TY, they did trail the Gamecocks by 2 TD's in the 4Q and the Bulldogs are a much better tm than SC. The final rubber stamp for us is a powerful MSt run offense that is avg 264 ypg and will be facing a KY D that all'd 237 rush to Florida, 282 rush vs S Car and LW all'd 303 (5.9) to LSU.

CLEMSON by 17 over Syracuse - LY was only recent meeting. CU led 35-7 at HT w/a 439-139 yd edge. With :10 left in the 1H, CU kept their offense on the field and tv cameras captured Shafer hurling expletives in Swinney's direction. The Tigers would win 49-14 (-14). This is SU's 2nd str AG while CU has a bye next week. The Orange are 2-6 ATS as an AD while Clem is 6-3 ATS as a HF. LW the Orange got a 42 yd IR TD, a 51 yd FR TD and WF lost their QB in the 2Q that keyed a 30-7 (-6) win. The Orange did have a 370-170 yd edge. On the other side, Clemson should have easily covered LW vs BC as they had 22-11 FD and 398-263 edges. BC's #4 rush offense in the country was held to season-low 120 yds, and 43 of that came on a late run. Clemson won 17-13 (-4'). QB Stoudt's shoulder was not 100% and he had to take a shot before the game and at HT but still was 29-45-285 in the rain. The Tigers are +157 ypg vs the #18 sked, have a bye on deck and their underrated D (#4) should feast on a bkp QB.

However, that changed LW as Akron bkp QB Tommy Woodson in his 1st start (Pohl inj) hit 23-45-268 but a late fumble & 22 yd FG w/1:55 left gave Ohio a 23-20 win (-3) over the Zips. The yds and FD's were even. The Chips were rolling along thanks to having RB Rawls and WR Davis in the lineup and while they had a 426-287 yd edge LW, they fell to Ball St 32-29 (-10) as they had a 5-1 TO deficit. Still the gm was tied late until BSt hit a 55-yd FG w/:17 left. On the other side, we were shocked to see UB fire HC Quinn as he was coming off an 8-5 season, was 3-4 TY but apparently there had to be some issues between him and the AD following the upset loss to E Mich 37-27 (-14'). The interim HC is OC Alex Wood who has been here 4 yrs and was the HC at James Madison from 1995-98. The UB D is all'g 89 ypg more than what their opp are avg (#114) and will have trouble containing CM's dynamic duo as we think CM is the far superior tm and are coming off a misleading final

W MICHIGAN by 6 over Ohio - WM is 20-7 SU s/76 vs OU. The L/gm was in '08 and the Broncos won 41-20 (-7). The 21 pt MOV was the largest in this series for WM s/'91. After a dismal 1-11 first season under HC Fleck, the Broncos are one of the MIP tms in the country TY at 4-3 and they have now covered 6 str gms after LW's 26-14 upset (+2') over BG. In fact, their only non-cover TY came in the opener by a 1/2 pt to Purdue. LW they held a Falcon offense that came in avg 481 ypg to just 274 yds. Their star has been RB Franklin who already has 992 yds (5.6). On the other side Ohio is coming off their best win of the ssn (although it came against a bkp QB) as they upset the Zips 23-20 (+3) to get them to 4-4 on the year and in bowl contention. WM hasn't been a MAC HF since 2012 and how will they handle success? Boston College by 10 over WAKE FOREST - BC had won 4 in a row SU/ATS in this series from '07-'10 but WF won and covered in '11 and '12. LY the game was on a Friday night and BC got td "drives' of 26 and 22 yds after fumbles to lead 17-7. WF was SOD at the BC 1-yd line w/:12 left in the 1H and BC only had a 170-160 yd edge but led by 10. BC would control the 2H and won 24-10 (-3). Situational edge to WF here as they are at home for a 2nd str wk with a bye on deck and had a bye 2 wks ago while BC plays their 2nd road gm in 3 wks with a road trip to VT on deck. The Eagles are off a big effort vs Clemson LW as they lost 17-13 (+4'). It should be noted, however that they were outFD'd 22-11 and outgained 398-263. BC's #4 rush offense in the country was held to season-low 120 yds, and 43 of that came on a late run. LW WF lost QB Wolford in the 2Q and they managed just 68 yds after he left. While they did get outgained 370-170, Syracuse got 2 def td's in the 30-7 (+6') final. Technical edges also favor the Deacons here as they are 18-9-1 ATS as a HD while BC is 4-13 ATS as an AF. However, the health of their QB (? here) has us backing off this gm plus we think they are outmanned at the LOS. UCF by 10 over Temple - LY was their first meeting and TU deserved to win. The Owls were a 17' pt dog but led most of the game and got a td and 2 pt conv with 2:04 left to go up 36-29. A 1-handed catch in the EŽ all'd UCF to tie it w/1:06 left. TU punted with w/:19 left and UCF got a 64 yd pass to the 6 and a 23 yd fg on the final play to escape. Both tms come in 4-2 SU/3-3 ATS but the diff is UCF has played the much tougher

sked. LW UCF led Tulane 20-6 with the Green Wave getting a 82-yd TD drive in the 4Q. UCF held on for a win despite getting outgained 278-233 and having 4 TO's. UCF is 17-10 ATS as a HF (Bright House!) but Temple is 6-1 ATS as an AD. However, that non-cover came LW vs Houston as they lost 31-10 (+7') getting outgained 439-357, outFD'd 23-11 and lost the TOP battle 42:33-17:27 while also having a -4 TO deficit. They are just +27 ypg vs the #120 sked. It is also their 2nd str long road trip while UCF is playing their 3rd straight at home. LY's gm will certainly keep UCF's attention and we think they take care of business here. VIRĞINIA by 4 over North Carolina - The ACC's longest running rivalry as they have played every yr s/1919. From '06-'09, UVA was 4-0 SU/ATS but NC has been 4-0 SU/ATS the L/4Y winning by an avg of 39-11 despite the avg line being -8. LTH NC was -3' but rolled to a 37-13 win. LY NC won 45-14 (-12'). NC is off of Clem, VTech, ND and GTech and has Miami, FI on deck in one of the toughest stretches any tm faces in CFB TY. UVA had a bye and Duke the L2W and this is their first HG in 3 wks. LY after a tough start, the light bulb went on for NC in a loss vs a solid tm (Miami) and TY the same thing could have happened in a loss vs ND as they beat GT LW 48-43 (E). NC led 42-31 but needed a TD w/:11 left for the win 48-43. The two tms combined for 1,190 yds and 60 FD's. The same couldn't be said in the UVA/Duke gm as we cashed a 3★ LPS Totals play on the UNDER. Despite having a 465-334 yd edge, UVA lost 20-13 (+3'). The game was tied most of the 2H and it was UVA's first non-cover of the ssn. While UNC has the offensive edge (#20-53), UVA has a massive D edge (#17-107). Could UNC duplicate LY?

PITTSBURGH by 6 over Georgia Tech - LY was first meeting s/76. At the half GT had a 217-65 yd edge and only led 14-3. Pitt gained 56 of their 228 yds on the last drive and GT would win 21-10 (-10'). Pitt has the situational edge here coming off a Thur Night home win vs VT and just had a bye a couple wks ago (sneak in some pract time to prep for option?) while GT is on their 2nd str AG after a big effort at NC LW. The Yellow Jackets were down 42-31 but rallied to take a 43-42 lead only to watch NC score a td w/:11 left. GT had a 611-579 yd edge and the tms combined for 60 FD's. Pts were at a premium in the VT/Pitt gm and we cashed a Thur Night marquee on the UNDER as Pitt won 21-16 (-1'). Pitt held VT to w/out a FD until mid-2Q but were outFD'd 16-15 for the gm. They did take adv of a beat-up VT RB's corps holding them to just 26 yds on 22 attempts and on the other side QB Voytik showed his mobility w/118 rush yds. While they are never going to win with style pts, the Panthers do a good job of controlling the LOS TY as they are avg a 239-111 rush yd edge (5.2 to 3.3 ypc) and we'll call for them to get a 2nd str ACC home win.

MISSOURI by 21 over Vanderbilt - MO is off 2 big games vs UGA and Fla while VU just had Charleston

Sthrn and a bye. LY the game was pick-em and it was our 'almost 5★'. MO did not punt until 10:00 was left in the 4Q. MO led 30-7 at the half with a 288-109 yd edge and would cruise 51-28. LTH MO had 2 long drives, both for FG's with QB Franklin in but he was inj'd and out for the gm and VU rallied for a 19-15 win (+7). LW's Mizzou/UF gm will go down as one of the most misleading gms of the yr as despite getting outFD'd 17-7 and outgained 283-119, Mizzou blew out the Gators 42-13 (+5') as they had a 96-yd KR td an 82-yd PR td, a 21 yd FR td and a 46-yd IR td. QB Mauk continues to struggle big time as he was just 6-18-20-0-1 and in the L/3 gms is a miserable 27-73-249-0-5. The Mizzou offense in fact has avg'd just 182 ypg the L/3 wks but somehow won 2 out of the 3 gms. We expect them to get a few more yds this wk vs a Vandy D that is all'g 456 ypg in SEC play TY and have a HC that is well over his head at this pt during his 1st season. Their 2 wins TY have come over the likes of UMass and Charleston Southern by a combined

4 pts and they have been beaten by an avg of 24 ppg in their 5 losses. Tigers in a route.

NAVY by 7 over San Jose St - Former SJSt HC McIntrye did a fine job prepping for the option as they held Navy to 344 and 144 yds in their 2 meetings. SJS was +6' at home vs Navy in '11 with Navy needing a win to stay bowl elig but pulled the upset 27-24. LTH ('12) they flew across country and shutout the Midshipmen 12-0 (-2'). LY SJ was -2' at home and Navy got the series' 2nd upset in 3Y winning in 30T's, 58-52. It was Caragher's first look at the option and Navy had 432 yds rush (7.0). Keenan Reynolds set an NCAA record by scoring 7 rushing td but 3 were in OT. We had a 3 ★ Totals LPS on the OVER. Navy has disappointed so far TY at 3-4 and will need all the wins they can get down the stretch to get to a bowl (still have ND, S Bama, Ga South). QB Reynolds missed the VMI gm (won 51-14, -38) but should be back here (shid'r). On the other side, SJSt's D is legit TY as they rank #12 in the country in total D (DC is Greg Robinson). LW they held Wyoming to 73 yds thru 3Q's but needed OT to win 27-20 (-2') despite having 31-11 FD and 471-277 yd edges. While they have impressed so far TY, this isn't a good situation for them coming off a big conf road game and now having to travel coast to coast to face Navy off a bye on HC.

UTAH ST by 21 over Univ - Utah St is 4-2 SU /ATS in this series. LTH Utah St was -20' and only led 20-13 in the 4Q but got 74 and 17 yd td passes and then a safety w/5:10 left for the frontdoor cover, 35-13. LY frosh QB Garretson got his first start and they were still -14' on the road. LV led the majority of the game. The Aggies went 88/7 to take the lead w/3:09 left and LV had a 1&10 from the USt16 w/:35 left and all 3 timeouts but threw 4x into the EZ, not utilizing the clock or time-outs and all 4 were incomp and Utah St escaped 28-24. The bad news on the injury front continues for Utah St as they had already lost QB Keeton for the yr earlier and then LW lost bkp QB Garretson in the 3Q (arm in sling, doubtful here). The 3rd stringer Harrison was only 5-12-28 in his place. The Aggies had won 11 conf road gms in a row but Colo St got a 46 yd FG on the last play to end it 16-13 (+5'). UNLV comes in off a bye (upset Fresno 30-27, +9' in L/gm) but has lost to SDSt, Hou and SJSt on the road by 24 ppg. Even w/a 3rd stringer at QB, we'll back the Aggies here as UNLV is 8-16 ATS as AD and Utah St has the huge D edge (#39-124)

TOLEDO by 15 over Massachusetts - Toledo is 2-1 vs UMass (only series loss in '76 in Amherst MA). The L/gm was at the Glass Bowl in '99, UT won 24-3. Whipple was also the HC for that game. The Minutemen have strung together B2B wins for the first time in their FBS history as they beat E Mich LW 36-14 (-14'), their 4th straight cover. The key sequence happened right before the half as EM had a FG blk'd and UMass got a FG right before the half to go up 30-14. UMass did have a 562-280 yd edge. However, this is not a good situation for them as they now have to travel playing a 9th straight week, while UT is fresh off a bye, this is their HC and they are the lone remaining unbeaten team in the MAC at 3-0. It should be noted that they are on a 0-6 ATS run TY vs FBS tms. However, they are +60 ypg TY vs the #91 sked while UMass is -23 ypg vs the #110 sked and UT's run offense avg 242 rush ypg (6.1)

and is fully capable of wearing them down.

Ucla by 10 over COLORADO - UCLA has now won all 3 P12 meetings but they keep getting closer as they won 45-6 at home in '11, 42-14 away in '12 and only 45-23 LY (-28'). They were +324 yds, +183 and just +31 LY. LW UCLA had a 567-366 yard edge at Cal but needed a questionable juggling int at the 2 to escape with a 36-34 win (-7). It was their first win at Cal since 1998. Col is off a 56-28 loss (+20') to USC as the gm wasn't nearly as close as the final as USC led 42-7 at one pt and for the 2nd time TY, Colorado all'd a QB to throw 7 td passes against them and this time it happened in 3Q's and didn't need OT. That's not good news facing UCLA QB Hundley who is now also getting more involved in the ground gm with 183 rush yds the L/2 wks. The Bruins have played our #1 sked and they are +43 ypg

while Colorado is a respectable +54 ypg vs the #22 sked. Look for a lot of pts.

NEBRASKA by 21 over Rutgers - Nebraska beat Rutgers 28-0 in their only series game (1920, New York, NY). The Cornhuskers come in off a somewhat misleading 38-17 win (-7) over Northwestern as they actually trailed 17-14 at HT. They did have a 471-290 yd edge and have now covered 5 str gms. The Huskers have had a lot of great RB's but Ameer Abdullah is the 1st to have three 1,000-yd rush seasons. On the flip side, we easily cashed a 4★ LPS and 3★ Key Selection on these pages going against the Scarlet Knights in their 1st B10 AG LW. Rutgers had their worst loss in 12 yrs and it could have been worse as Ohio St led 49-7 mid-3Q and won 56-17 (+21). Now they have to make a 2nd str long trip after getting run over for 324 rush yds (8.1!) and face a Neb tm avg 374 rush ypg (7.0!) at home TY. Also notable is the fact that Rutgers despite their 5-2 record are actually -9 ypg TY while Nebraska is +185 ypg!

MIAMI, OH by 6 over Kent St - MU had dominated this rivalry going 17-2 SU from '89-'07. KS has turned the tables going 4-2 SU/ATS since. The visitor is also 6-3 SU/ATS and there have been 4 outright upsets the L8Y. Kent St hired Don Treadwell who was fired as Miami's coach at mid-year in 2013 and has of course great knowledge of the team and maybe an ax to grind. LY KS was -17 at home but only led 14-6 at the half with a 197-144 yd edge. KS got a 23 yd fg to get ahead of the spread, 24-6 w/6:32 left. LTH KS was -6' and led 35-10 at the half and 48-25 before a late MU td w/1:58 left. LW KSt won its first game of season as QB Reardon hit 27-40-360. They only led 20-17 in 3Q but won 39-17 (+3') as they had a 467-330 yd edge. The Redhawks weren't as fortunate as their opp N Illinois had 658 yds of offense and rushed for 7.9 ypc. MU did get a backdoor td w/2:36 left to lose 51-41 (+13'). QB Hendrix was 23-42-346-2-0 and also rushed for 72 yds and 3 td. While the RedHawks are 1-7, they are only getting outgained by 57 ypg vs the #86 sked while Kent St is -144 ypg vs the #75 sked. MU picks up their 2nd win!

ARKANSAS by 24 over Uab - Homecoming & first meeting between these two schls. UAB is 2-23 SU all-time vs SEC tms with the avg score 34-14 (beat LSU 13-10 in '00 & MSU 27-13 in '04) and the Blazers have dropped 22 str non-conf AG's (L/win in '05 at Troy). After covering 5 str gms & looking improved following inspired efforts vs A&M & Bama, the Hogs were embarrassed 45-32 (+3') vs UGA Ark took an early 6-0 lead (PAT blk'd) but then all'd 38 str before responding in the 2H. They did have 29-18 FD & 422-386 yd edges but also had 4 TO's. UAB is off a 34-22 loss at MT (-1') as they couldn't hold onto a 22-21 4Q lead. The Blazers had 25-13 FD & 405-370 yd edges but were done in by 3 TO's. Ark has MSU on deck and after going 1-7 the L2Y as a HF, are 2-0 in that role TY incl a 52-14 win over Ark has MSU on deck and after going 1-7 the L27 as a FIT, are 2-0 if that fole 1.1 fit of a 22-14 with over N Illinois tm earlier TY that we cashed as 3★ Key selection on these pages. Despite playing the #2 sked, the Hogs are +79 ypg & +11 ppg TY and we like them to take adv of a UAB rush D that has all'd 235 ypg (5.6) vs their 3 toughest opp TY.

Memphis by 21 over SMU - SMU has won 3 in a row SU/ATS in this series & surprisingly after SMU.

werining by 21 ver swo - Swo 13 in a row 50/A 3 in this series & sulprisingly after 5wo won in '11 and '12 by an avg of 43-6 (+332 ypg), they were +3' at UM LY. The 34-29 final score was misleading. SMU led 31-3 at HT & 34-3 late 3Q. UM got a 15 yd FR td. An 8 yd td on the final play of the game capped an 80 yd garbage drive. LTH ('12) SMU won 44-13 (-21'). UM only was able to muster 202 yds & 9 FD's. SMU is off a 41-3 (+13) loss to Cincy to remain winless on the ssn. They were outFD'd 29-14 & outg'd 508-276 & had 4 TO's. UM is fresh off a bye & was upset 28-24 (-7') at home to Houston prior. SMU is 8-5 as a HD but is 0-3 TY being outscored 155-9, while UM is just 2-6-1 as an AF s/04 but finds itself in that role for the 1st time TY. They have 1 common foe in Cincy & UM had a +258 yd edge in their 27 pt win on the road while we just detailed SMU's box from LW. Look for Memphis to continue SMU's woes here.

STANFORD by 13 over Oregon St - Homecoming. The HT is 5-2 SU/4-3 ATS but SU is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS. LY OSU had a 23-13 FD edge (+4'). Mannion went 41-57 but for just 6.6 ypc. SU led 7-3 at HT (162-82 yd edge). Up 8, SU punted w/1:34 left and after OSU had a 1&gl from the SU7, SU forced 4 str inc passes (last w/:01) as SU won 20-12 (-4'). LTH ('12) OSU forced 4 TO's but lost 27-23 (4'). SU led 14-0 but OSU scored the next 23. OSU all'd a 29/6pl GW td w/5:07 left and their L/2 drives ended in a punt & SOD at own 31. SU all'd their most pts TY in their 26-10 (-3') loss to AZSt as the Cardinal were held to just 14 FD's & 288 yds. The key play happened when Stanford PR Montgomery fumbled and set up a 12 yd TD drive with 2:00 left in the half. OSU is off a 2OT 29-23 (+2) loss to Utah despite having 20-16 FD & 391-315 yd edgs. They've pi'd 1 common foe in USC & SU had a 122 yd edge in the 3 pt loss while OSU was outg'd by 280 yds in their 25 pt loss. While OSU just had a bye 2W ago, 2 extra days to prep & Stanford in Ariz St/UO road sandwich, we look for the Cardinal to get a bounce back here.

Alabama by 17 over TENNESSEE - A traditional cigar goes to the winner of this game, which was always played on the 3rd Sat in Oct. Once again the SEC sked maker didn't get it right as Bama is pl'g their 3rd road gm in 4 wks but has a bye on deck. Bama has won 7 in a row SU by an avg of 25 ppg & 4 str ATS with the 7 str wins being the most by either tm in the 112-yr old series. Bama OC Kiffin travels back to Knoxville where he left the Vols. LY Bama was pumped up as UT was referring to them as the "red team." The Tide did only have 479-322 yd & 26-14 FD edges in the 45-10 (-38) win. LTH ('12) Bama never trailed and from the 11:23 2Q mark led by DD the rest of the way in the 44-13 (-20) route. After talk of Bama perhaps losing their mojo following B2B unimpressive performances, an angry Tide shutout A&M 59-0 (-13') with 30-8 FD & 602-172 yd edges. The 35 2Q pts set a schl rec & it was the their most lopsided SEC win s/79 (66-3 vs Vandy). UT is off a 34-3 (+17) loss to Ole Miss as the Vol's were held to 0 rush yds becoming the 1st SEC tm to do so s/'11' (Florida). While Bama is clearly the better tm they are avg just 311 ypg on the road (613 at home) and Tenn D is all'g just 252 ypg at home.

MICHIGAN ST by 21 over Michigan - 107th meeting, played for Paul Bunyan Trophy. The team with the most rushing yds has won 41 of the L/44. MSU HC Dantonio has disliked UM from numerous angles. He was a ND fan as a kid, a DC for Ohio St and a MSU asst under Saban. In '07 UM won their 6th straight in the series and Mike Hart made his famous "Little Brother" comment. Since then MSU is 5-1 SU and a perfect 6-0 ATS. MSU gets UM at home a 2nd str yr. LY's 29-6 (-4') win was the most lopsided s'/67 (34-0) as UM vowed that they had been bullied in the previous meeting and that wouldn't happen again but UM had -48 yds rushing, their worst output in schl history. We had a 4★ LPS on MSU and it was 6-6 with 3:00 left 1H but MSU scored 23 unanswered. UM is fresh off a bye while MSU is off a 56-17 (-14') win over Indiana as after being down 17-14 2Q, the Spartans scored 42 str. They all'd just 7 FDs. Under Hoke UM is just 3-7 as an AD incl 0-2 TY and despite the fact this is Mich St's largest favorite role in series history (never been favored by more than a td s/76) they did not finish vs Nebraska earlier TY leading 27-3 in 4Q and that will be a point of emphasis here.

COLORADO ST by 17 over Wyoming - The Border War has been pi'd every yr s' 46 (winner awarded the Bronze Boot). CSU leads 56-44-5. Former WY HC Christensen put a lot of emphasis on this gm & had won 4 in a row from '09-'12 but LY was -6 at home and surprisingly CSU dominated. The Rams were up 38-15 after 3Q's winning 52-22 as CSU delivered another outright upset as a Big Dog POW. It was WY's worst loss in the 105 prev Border War games. CSU is off a 16-13 (-4') win over UTSt as they kicked the GW 46 yd FG w/no time left. They did benefit from playing a 3rd string QB. WY is off a 27-20 (+1) OT loss to SJSt as they were held to just 11 FD's & 277 ttl yds (4 FD & 73 ttl yds thru 3Q!). The HT is on an 8-3 ATS run in this series and there is a lot of excitement for this Rams team as they had their 1st sellout since 2004 LW.

Arizona by 7 over WASHINGTON ST - This marks the 40th all-time meeting (AZ is 19-9 SU s'82). This is now our 33rd yr in business and way back in our first 2 years of 1982 and 1983 we used AZ over WSt as our 5★ GOY and they delivered easy wins both times. WSU had won 4 in a row SU from '01-'04 but AZ then won 5 in a row SU from '06-'10 by an avg of 41-16. They took 2Y off and LY AZ was coming off an emotional 5 pt loss to UCLA and had a big game vs Oregon on deck & AZSt after that so this was an obvious trap gm. WSt had 16 days to prep for the game! Tied at 17 4Q, WSt went on an 80/10 td drive with 2:15 left for the lead. AZ got to the WS13 and caught a pass in the EZ but the rec was a step OOB as WSt held on 24-17 (+11), snapping a series high 5 gm losing streak. The HT is 4-1 ATS. They've had 3 common foes (NV, Cal & Oreg) & AZ is 3-0 SU avg +60 ypg edge while WSt is 0-3 SU but has an avg of +108 yd edge. AZ is getting better each wk with young skill pos players and coming off a loss, off a bye, !'Il call for them to get revenge here.

Usc by 3 over UTAH - USC is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS and the HT is 3-0 ATS in this series as P12 rivals. LTH

LTH ('12) Utah was fired up & USC trailed 21-10 mid-2Q but led 38-21 before giving up a late garbage td for Utah's cover w/:38 left (+14). LY USC's PK Heidari who was much maligned on the season hit his first 4 fg's. Utah jumped out to a 3-0 lead on a 42 yd fg but did not score again. USC led 16-3 at HT & we easily won our CTOT GOM on UNDER 52 (19-3 final). USC is 1-9 ATS as an AF incl being upset outright at BC earlier TY. USC is off a 56-28 (-21) win over Colo as QB Kessler set a schl rec with 7 td passes while becoming the 1st P12 QB in history with 7 td passes in the first 3Q's. Utah is off a thrilling 2OT 29-23 (-2) win last Thurs. RB Booker rushed 229 yds & 3 td's as the Utes are off to their best start s/10. Utah is 7-3 as a HD, even upsetting Stanford here LY. The last time Utah beat USC in the reg ssn was 1916 and we'll call for that streak to continue as keep in mind, USC has won at Stanford and at Arizona this year.

Georgia Southern by 17 over GEORGIA ST - First meeting. Expect this to become a rivalry. While these 2 schools are 209 mile apart this is GSt's first gm vs an in-state foe. GSt should benefit from having played AF and the option back on Sept 13th (did allow 539 yds and 48 pts and the gm was misleading). However, they have allowed 384 rush (7.2) and 321 rush (5.9) in the last 2 weeks as they are down to 69 schl players. Still GSt nearly pulled off a huge upset in their 30-27 (+17) loss at SA LW. Up 27-23 4Q, the Panthers all'd the GW 18 yd td pass with 4:02 left. GSo is off a bye & a 47-24 (-24') home win vs ID the wk prior. They are arguably the most surprising tm in the SBC TY as they are 5-2 SU/ATS and are +107 ypg while playing a similar sked to Ga St who is -56 ypg. Eagles roll.

They are starting to figure themselves out and its very impressive that they have the #13 pass offense with Austin Davis who was the Rams #4 QB when camp started. In his 5 starts he has a solid 96.4 QBR built around 262 ypg (66%) 9-3 and has taken a decent 11 sacks so far. This is while Fisher is still searching for a starting RB though Mason tallied 85 yds (4.7) vs SEA. The Chiefs are one of the worst HF's in the league with a 2-11 ATS record and LW's win vs SD wasn't a surprise considering how good Reid's teams are after a bye. Detroit by 7 over ATLANTA - London - This is a 9:30 am EST start. The Lions have a commanding edge with their #2 defense led by their DL (#2 sacks 21) against the Falcons OL which is struggling with the run (#23 67 ypg 4.0 the L3W). ATL is 19th in sacks allowed (15) but are now down to their #3 Ctr after Konz (knee) was KO'd LW. Ryan may have a quick release to avoid sacks but he owns a 76.2 QBR on the road TY and now have to make the long flight across the Atlantic after being hammered at BAL. DET may not have Megatron again but the Lions deserve credit for rallying from 13 down in the 4th Qtr vs NO to snare the win at home. Neither QB excels on the road but Favorites are 13-4 ATS if both teams have a bye on deck, the Lions are healthier, are +42 ypg vs -24 ypg for ATL, have more depth and we'll take them by a TD here vs the reeling and predictable Falcons.

TAMPA BAY by 6 over Minnesota - The Bucs have the situational edge at home off a bye vs a foe in its second straight game. TB and HOU are the only teams to not have won the yardage battle TY but keep in mind the Bucs schedule before the bye. The public will only remember the brutal loss vs BAL but they were home after a 3 game road streak where they switched QB's mid-game, beat PIT late, took NO to OT and were caught looking ahead to rest. Also keep in mind the QB's faced in that streak and they get a huge step down vs Bridgewater with an OL that has allowed 19 sacks the L3W with a 46.8 QBR in that span vs a defense that a defense that has allowed a 94.4 QBR. TB has been a disappointment thus far but expect their best effort as the coaching staff was able to catch its breath and the players got some much needed rest over the bye while MIN travels again.

NEW ENGLAND by 9 over Chicago - NE is 14-4 ATS as a single digit HF and have a big edge with extra rest after their narrow escape vs the Jets. While the stats haven't been stellar the L3W (+48 ypg) Brady has logged QBR's of 110.6, 139.6, 103.6 in that span. Gronkowski is starting to get into football form avg 87 ypg (14.6) and the Patriots still own the #12 defense with 18 sacks (#9). Cutler may have nice stats (267 ypg 67% 14-7) but he still makes TO's at the worst time and the Bears are giving up 108 ypg (4.3) on the ground. While the Bears have a 74.5 defensive QBR on the road TY that's vs Kaepernick with the staff in pass first mode, Geno Smith, a one-dimensional CAR team and the injury depleted Falcons. NE does have DEN on deck but they are 14-3-1 ATS after a DIV win and getting a dinged up CHI secondary at home.

Seattle by 9 over CAROLINA - This is the 1st B2B loss for SEA since mid-2012 and the Seahawks are 7-1 ATS afterwards. While the Harvin trade raised eyebrows the big story is that their secondary has allowed 3 straight games with a QBR of 101.9 or higher. SEA was down 21-3 vs STL but pulled to within 2 late in the 4th Qtr thanks to Wilson who bounced back from his bad day vs DAL to his 5th game with a QBR of 110+ and added 106 yds rushing as the Seahawks posted a 16-9 FD and 303-161 yd edge in the 2H. CAR's loss was worse than it looked as GB had a 35-3 before relaxing and giving up 135 yds in garbage time as the Panthers were so frustrated stud LB Kuechly was ejected. Newton is fully healthy but his QBR has declined from 110.8 vs PIT to 73.5 vs GB as the téam lacks weapons aside from Benjamin/Olsen and the team has been outrushed by 48 ypg. CAR also lost their starting RG Turner (knee) and LT Bell (elbow) with Newton getting hit 17 times LW We'll take the angry road team vs a thin CAR team giving up a 48% 3rd Dn rate on defense.

NY JETS by 7 over Buffalo - The Jets are 2-5 ATS after facing the Patriots but they played their best game of the year with a 100 yd edge over the Patriots. Smith made good safe decisions in the passing game (88.6) but they struggled to salt the game away with 4 FG's inside the NE 30. Their #16 pass defense with a 108.3 QBR gets a big break after facing 6 elite QB's in a row and Orton isn't going to have RB's Jackson/Spiller who've earned 38.4% of the Bills #22 offense. BUF gave up 39 more rush yds vs MIN than in their previous 2 games combined and the Jets own the #7 rush offense avg 137 ypg (4.7). Yes, the Bills are 2-1 under Orton but they've led for a grand total of 5 seconds in those games. Div home teams off a Thursday game are 17-6 ATS, the Jets made a bold move getting Harvin and the Bills last second non-cover doesn't hurt the line value.

Miami by 7 over JACKSONVILLE - AF's that were AD's in their last game are on a 17-5 SU/ATS run. After coming close vs GB the Dolphins played their best game of the year vs CHI with a 24-14 FD and 393-224 yd edge. Over his L3 games Tannehill has avg'd 266 ypg (72%) 6-3 with a 105.8 QBR. After facing the #12, #7 and #18 pass defenses he gets the Jaguars #30 pass defense with a 100.0 QBR. After matching up against Rodgers/Cutler the #4 defense gets Bortles who has done fairly well with 4 games of 80+ QBR in his 5 appearances. While JAX rushed for a season high 185 yds (5.3) vs CLE's #32 rush defense that was dinged up front they now face the #10 stop unit allowing 100 ypg (3.8). JAX is happy after securing their 1st win of the season over a flat CLE team travelling without its All-Pro Ctr but they may not have LB Posluszny (pectoral) or DE Branch (knee) here. MIA is gaining confidence and this isn't that far of a road game for them so expect a few Dolphins fans here.

Houston by 4TENNESSEE - HOU is 8-3 ATS vs the Texans and the road team has covered 3 straight.

The Texans are off MNF vs the Steelers and this is their 3rd road game in a 4 week span. HOU had a 50/50 shot to play Clowney in limited situations which doesn't bode well for a TEN OL that is 26th in sacks allowed (18). Whitehurst has been decent but the Titans struggle to run the ball (#177) with 77 ypg (3.7) in 3 of the L4 games. They simply don't have the players on offense to run Whisenhunt's system correctly and it shows in their #27 yardage and #28 scoring rankings on offense. HOU has yet to win the yardage battle in a game TY but do take a big step down after facing Romo, Luck and Roethlisberger the L3W. Fitzpatrick is simply too inconsistent though as while he has a decent 86.4 QBR he only has a 6-6 ratio and if Foster can't get going (TEN giving up 124 ypg 4.0 #21 rush def) he struggles. That said Chip Kelly is an unconventional coach who plays by his own rules and is 5-1 despite an OL blasted by injuries. After giving up 5 sacks to JAX, PHI has allowed just 2 and while Foles (82.0 QBR) and McCoy (1 100-yd rush game) aren't sneaking up on anyone TY, 4 players have 19 or more rec's. Defensively PHI is playing situational ball with 35% allowed on 3rd Dns which is top 10, are 7th with 19 sacks by and are 1 of 5 teams who are top 10 in Off Ypp and Def YPP. ARZ has the #28 and #18 units (+6 TO's) being outgained by 40 ypg so far TY. They've been very fortunate with their schedule also and have a road game vs DAL on deck after Palmer faced his former team. We'll side with the Eagles getting points as they keep pace with the surprising Cowboys.

CLEVELAND by 9 over Oakland - OAK is 0-15 SU but have covered 4 of their L5 in EST games

and this is only the 6th time CLE has been favored by a TD since 1999. CLE's loss LW came down to the Browns intercepting Bortles late in the 2Q up 6-0 and 4 plays later eschewing the easy FG and getting SOD which gave the Jags confidence. Later in the 4th Qtr CLE was SOD on 4th&5 at midfield and then muffed a punt which allowed JAX to seal the game away with an 8 yd TD. Hoyer couldn't get on track all game but at home he has a 101 QBR vs 77.7 on the road. OAK was worse than the final score indicated being outFD 25-13 and outgained 365-220 and own a 73.3 QBR minus the SD game. OAK is 29th vs the run which is good news for CLE. Look for the home team to rebound vs a QB/HC tandem making their 1st road trip together vs a defense that snared 3 Ints on the road vs a rookie QB that will now be backed by a raucous home crowd.

Green Bay at New Orleans - Rogers vs Brees is worth the price of admission. The Saints were dominant winning 16 straight at home and going 15-0-1 ATS under HC Payton into this season. They did need a TD with under 5 min left to cover vs MIN but then needed OT vs TB just to pull out the win giving them their first ATS loss in that span.
