4★ WISCONSIN over Usf - First meeting. It wouldn't be a 5★ Saturday w/out backing the Badgers as they have cashed multiple times for us incl three 5★ GOY winners s/00 with the last one coming in 2012, a 62-14 (-7) demolition of Indiana. LW, they moved to a perfect 8-0 ATS off a reg ssn bye easily cashing a 4★ on these pages w/a 68-17 win (-26) over BG while amassing a B10 record 644 rush yds. RB Gordon led the way running for a career-high 253 yds (19.5) and 5 td's after having a slow start to the ssn. It was kinda ironic considering his day started w/a fumble on his 1st carry, the 1st fumble in his entire career (322 att). Usf has also cashed a couple of 5★'s for us in recent years incl a 41-10 win (-16) over Syracuse as our 2007 GOY. They are off a 17-14 (-2) win over Conn cashing our Fri Night Marquee. The gm was a bit misleading as USF dominated w/17-6 FD and 271-132 yd edges w/a key play being a Conn 70-yd IR td w/05 left in the 1H. Earlier TY, NCState led by former Wisc OC Doeren ran for 315 yds on USF and we think these Badgers could even top that mark. Play "On Wisconsin!, On Wisconsin!" yet again!

FORECAST: WISCONSIN by 42

3★ LOUISVILLE over Wake Forest - In the only prior gm ('06 Orange Bowl) UL won 24-13. UL trailed by 3 just 4 seconds into the 4Q. UL went on B2B 4Q td drives (81/8pl & 71/10pl) while WF had to punt and was int'd at the UL15. The 3-1 SU/ATS Cards come in off a 34-3 win (-26) over FIU as they had a 336-205 yd edge. The gm was delayed for 1 hr, 5 min and after combining for 31 1H pts, they had just 6 in the 2H. LW the Deacs rallied from a 21-14 4Q deficit to beat Army 24-21 (+2). WF was aided by a 40-yd missed Army FG and an Army fumb'l at the WF 20 both when the Cadets were up 7. True frosh QB Wolford like most young QB's is a different player at home (comp 75%) than he is on the road (44%) and he is also better when he gets time in the pocket (sk'd 13 times on road TY) and that's not good news facing a UL D that is better than both ULM and Utah St. The closer here is Bobby Petrino's incredible record as a HF as he is 32-10-1 ATS dating back to 2004 and 31-7-1 ATS when you take out his one yr at WKU LY (non-power 5 conf tm not used to being a HF). Also we used Petrino in that HF role as our 2011 5★ GOY and his Ark tm rolled Tenn 49-7 (-14').

FORECAST: LOUISVILLE by 31

3★ CLEMSON over North Carolina - Home team has won 4 str. In the L/gm ('11) the Tigers won 59-38 (-11). CU led 59-24 into the 4Q despite just a 450-418 yd edge (IR & FR td's). Shockingly CU is 9-0 SU/7-2 ATS the wk following FSU, w/an avg win by 20 ppg. NC is 2-11 s/82 in Clemson incl 3 str losses by 25 ppg. The Tar Heels are 1-10 SU the last 4 ssn vs ranked opp's (8 str losses) and are coming off one of the most embarrassing performances we've ever seen from a defense. Despite playing w/revenge off a bye vs an ECU tm off a big upset win, the Tar Heels were destroyed 70-41 (+2) all g 789 yds, the most pts and yds ever allowed by the Heels. Clemson is off a 23-17 OT loss (+10) to a FSU sans-Jameis Winston tm. The Tigers had their chances but missed 2 short FG's and then Swinney elected to go for it on 4&1 in OT but were stuffed. A bright spot was the play of true frosh Watson who was 19-28-266-0-0 and had a rushing td. If UNC couldn't stop EC LW, how do you expect them to stop a Clemson tm that will only get better with QB Watson getting more and more exp? **The Tigers were our FREE Sept 5★ in 2009 and they beat BC 25-7 (-7). Will we go back to them again here?**

FORECAST: CLEMSON by 21

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ TCU over SMU - This is the battle for the Iron Skillet and TCU is 12-2 SU but SMU is 8-3 ATS. SMU knocked off #20 ranked TCU in '11 44-30 at TCU and had covered 4 in a row prior to LY. TCU had a very misleading 48-17 win LY as they only had a 16-15 FD edge, 332-292 yd edge. After a 51 yd PR, TCU went 22 yds for a td then converted on 4&2 and 4&8 and got a 26 yd fg, 34-10 4:22. SMU got a td w/3:00 left, 34-17 for the cover but TCU ret'd the inside kick 45 yds for the td and the frontdoor, 41-17. TCU then got a 66 yd IR td w/1:34 left for a very misleading final. TCU does have Okla, Baylor and Okla St on deck but is off a bye (2nd one in 3 wks). The Horned Frogs are one of the most improved tms in the country TY as they are outgaining their foes by 286 ypg and cashed a 2★ for us in their L/gm a 30-7 (-16) win over Minnesota. Meanwhile on the other side, SMU has already seen HC Jones resign and have by far the worst offense in the country avg just 194 ypg and 4 ppg. Their only td all yr came on a Hail Mary pass vs NT. LW we cashed a 2★ selection on these pages going against them as they lost 58-6 (+34) to A&M. The only question here is not who wins but whether or not SMU can score a single pt.

FORECAST: TCU by 42

2★ IDAHO over South Alabama - First meeting. SA is coming off their SBC opener, losing 28-6 (-2) to Ga Southern. They did have a slight 20-18 FD edge, but were outgained 420-296. Now they begin their 1st of B2B road trips with a visit to the unique Kibbie Dome. ID cont'd to struggle on the road LW in their 36-24 (+13) loss to Ohio. They were down 17-0 2Q before making a gm of it and held the FD edge 23-19, but were outgained 505-417 and all'd the Bobcats to have a commanding 39:08-20:52 TOP edge. The loss was their 18th str on the road (4-13-1 ATS). The Vandals D has been victimized again TY, allowing 508 ypg & 40 ppg, but the Jaguars offense isn't anything to write home about as they are avg 329 ypg & just 11 ppg. Tough to back a USA tm laying more than a td here vs a high-powered ID offense in a unique setting in their longest road trip in sch'l history. Upset!

OTHER GAMES

Thursday, September 25th

Appalachian St at GEORGIA SOUTHERN - These 2 prev So-Con foes comb for 9 FCS/IAA Nat'l Champ in 23Y ('85-'07) and both have made the jump to the FBS level TY. App St's 3 str wins in this series (8-3 L/11) tie them for their longest streak in a series that dates back to 1932. They won their last trip here 31-28 in '12, ending GS's 13-gm home win streak. LY GS led 7-0 but QB McKinnon sprained his ankle in the 2Q in a tie game and AS went on to upset #24 GS 38-14. Ga So comes into this gm 2-2 but is a perfect 4-0 ATS after LW's 28-6 win over S Bama. App St wasn't as fortunate as they lost to SMiss 21-20 getting a td w/06 left only to have their PAT blocked (also missed 3 FG's). Does Ga Southern continue its current ATS win streak or does App St continue their series win streak?

Texas Tech at OKLAHOMA ST - OSU has now won 5 in a row both SU/ATS. LTH OSU won 59-21 (-9'). LY Kingsbury hung up signs around the TT football building with "98" on them reminding them of the collective margins of OSU's previous 2 wins (66-6, 59-21). However, OSU became the first team to beat TT 3 str in Lubbock s/Neb in '00 as they won 52-34 (E). TY TT comes in at 2-1 but is 0-3 ATS failing to cover their 3 gms by 20 ppg. Their D coord resigned LW and they are all g 298 rush ypg (5.1). The Pokes are 2-1 SU/ATS and have a new str'g QB in Daxx Garman (57%, 4-0 ratio). Series and performance so far TY clearly side with the Pokes here but beware of throwing TT in the trash (see LY's bowl gm vs Ariz St).

Ucla at ARIZONA ST - UCLA is 8-5 SU/8-4-1 ATS in this series. The HT was 10-2 SU but the visitor has now won 2 in a row. The L3G have been decided by 1, 2 and 5 pts. LY was their first meeting as 2 ranked teams s/86 (at UCLA) and it was a battle for a P12 Title gm berth. ASU dominated early and was up 35-13 at the half (hung on 38-33, -2). LTH UCLA was down 43-42 but went 60/12pl nailing a GW 33 yd fg as time exp'd. Both tms come in at 3-0 and off a bye and both needed it as they saw their QB's get inj'd in their wins over Texas and Colorado. While UCLA QB Hundley (elbow) at presstime is ? for this one, ASU QB Kelly (foot) is out. We'll pass on this game for now and check the injury report later in the wk.

Friday, September 26th

Middle Tennessee at OLD DOMINION - First meeting. ODU is 30-7 SU (81%) at Foreman Field, and they have won 10 str reg ssn gms. This is ODU's first mid-week gm and it will be interesting to see how they handle success as they are coming off an upset win over LY's conf champs Rice 45-42 (+6). The Monarchs got a 25-yd FG on the final play but did benefit from Rice's QB being out most of the 1H and also got a 45-yd fake punt td pass. The Blue Raiders are just 4-12 s/07 playing mid-week gms but have won 3 of the L/4 (LY upset Marsh). They come in 2-2 after LW's 36-17 loss to Memphis as their powerful run gm was held to just 88 yds after avg 247 the 1st 3 gms. While MT is on B2B road on a short wk (also 3OT gm vs WKU 2 wks ago), ODU is 0-3 ATS as a HF.

Fresno St at NEW MEXICO - FSU has won 3 str both SU/ATS. LTH they trailed 24-7 late in the 2Q but would score 42 straight pts to lead 49-24 before a NM td w/47 left in their 49-32 (-15) win. LY NM was w/o their top QB Gautsche (777 rush, 6.6) and top RB Carrier (1122 yd, 5.9) and FSU cruised 69-28 (-33). Both tms got much needed wins LW as NM scored a td w/27 left to beat NM ST 38-35 (-3) while Fresno off 3 blowout losses to Power 5 conf tms beat S Utah 56-16 (-16). Both tms have struggled mightily on the D side TY as NM is all g 525 ypg while Fresno is all g 541 ypg! Which tm picks up an early MW win?

Saturday, September 27th

MICHIGAN ST by 28 over Wyoming - Homecoming. The Spartans are 2-0 vs the Cowboys but the last meeting was in 1977. Both tms have played Oreg TY and both lost (MSU by 19, WY by 34). LW the Pokes were dead in the water as they were down 19-17 and had just been SOD on 4&22 w/2:09 left. FAU fumbled deep in WY territory and WY got a 88-yd pass to set up a FG w/15 left to win 20-19 (-3'). It was their 3rd win TY by 5 pts or less despite avg just 18 ppg in those gms. MSU didn't need any last second fortune in their 73-14 win (-45) over EMU LW scoring their most pts s/89. The Spartans outgained EM 320-1 in the 1H and amazingly had a 20-0 FD edge at one pt! Coming into TY, the Spartans were 3-10 ATS as a HF but that was with stodgy offenses and TY are 2-0 ATS despite being at least a 5 td fav in both. However, the Spartans do have a huge gm vs Neb on deck while the Pokes (18-6 ATS as AD) have a bye.

MICHIGAN by 14 over Minnesota - Since Minn's last win in '05 (23-20, +7 in Big House), Mich is 6-0 SU/ATS (+226 ypg). The Wolverines have actually won 30 of the L/32 in the battle for the Little Brown Jug. LY this was the first gm Kill missed and Tracy Claeys was the acting HC and he led from the press-box. UM led 14-7 at the half with a 124-113 yd edge. Mich went 6:39 getting a td w/2:36 left, 35-13, then got a 72 yd IR td for a somewhat misleading final 42-13 (-19). The cries for Brady Hoke's head will only get louder after LW's 26-10 upset loss (-3') to Utah in a gm that saw a 2 hr 24 min lightning delay and the tms resumed to about 105,000 empty seats. After starting out a perfect 19-0 at home, LW the Gophers outgained their 1st opp all yr (387-254) in their 24-7 win (-10) over SUSt but w/o QB Leidner (CS) bkp Steveler hit just 1 of 7 for 7 yds for the gm but did have 161 rush yds. This is a good matchup for the Wolverines as the Gophers can be a great bully when they can run, but UM has a good run D all g 50 ypg and desperately need a win as they continue their series domination. **We cashed a Sept 5★ going against Minny in 2007 (lost to FAU 42-39, -7), will we do it again?**

Maryland by 1 over INDIANA - Indiana is 2-0 vs Maryland but the L/meeting was in 1935. UM just completed 61 yrs as an ACC member and this marks their inaugural Big Ten matchup. Both tms are coming off big road wins as the Terps upset the Cuse 34-20 (+2) while IU pulled off a huge shocker beating Mizzou 31-27 (+13'). MD entered LW's gm avg 37.7 PPG, the highest in sch'l history and they raced out to a 31-13 HT lead before struggling in the 2H. After losing to BG LW, Indy HC Wilson wanted his tm to "play with their hair on fire" vs Mizzou and they clearly got the message as their upset was no fluke (FD's and yds even) getting a td run w/22 left. Their RB Coleman is one of the best in the country and despite sitting 20 min LW w/cramps had 132 yds and a key 44-yd run on the final drive. Look for a lot of pts in this one and we'll back the away dog.

Baylor by 27 over IOWA ST - LY we had a 3★ College Totals play on the Over in this game and BU lived up to their end of the bargain. The Bears led 37-0 at half with a 461-74 yd edge. IS went 57/6 for a garbage td w/34 left to make it 64-7 and BU got a 97 yd KR w/22 left for the 71-7 (-33) final. The HT is a perfect 5-0 SU/ATS in the series w/BU losing here in '12 35-21 (+2) and in '09 24-10 (-1). Both come in off a bye. The 3-0 SU/ATS Bears are usually known for their offense and while they are avg 688 ypg and 59 ppg despite a mash unit at WR and QB Petty missing 1.5 gms, it is their defense that has made waves TY all g just 9 ppg and 221 ypg. The Cyclones looked dead in the water after their loss to FCS powerhouse NDS in the opener but have played well since nearly upsetting KSt (28-32, +12) and 2 wks ago upset in-state rival Iowa 20-17 (+13) getting a FG on the final play. However, the Bears should be getting much more healthy at the WR spot for this one, and with TY's defense, we are not afraid to play against them on the road.

VIRGINIA by 28 over Kent St - First meeting. LW we cashed a 2★ on these pages backing UVA for the 3rd time TY in an underdog role as they lost to BYU 41-33 (+14'). The 4-0 ATS Cavs deserved better in the gm as they led at HT and had huge 35-16 FD, 519-332 yd and 40:55-19:05 TOP edges but were done in by settling for FG's after 4 long drives and also all'd a 99-yd KR td. Their D despite playing 3 ranked tms already TY is all g just 102 rush ypg (3.1) and that's not good news for a Kent St tm that has a non-existent run gm avg 47 ypg (1.9). The Flashes are 0-3 SU/ATS getting outgained by 238 ypg and in their L/gm were completely embarrassed by Ohio St 66-0 (+31) as we easily cashed another Early Bird POW winner on the Bucks (given out FREE every Monday on button #9 by calling 1-347-677-1700). While we are impressed w/UVA's start to the ssn particularly in their underdog roles, they need to start taking care of business as a large fav (just 3-8-1 ATS as a HF) if they truly want to take the next step.

Temple by 14 over CONNECTICUT - These two are 4-4 SU but TU covered the first 7 meetings until LY. TU (-7) led 21-0 at the half with a 271-64 yd edge but CT tied it with 6:52 left then got a 59 yd IR td for the win. LTH CT led 14-0 after 1Q but TU got a td w/19 left to force OT and a 29 yd fg to win in OT. The visitor is 3-1 SU/5-2 ATS and there have been 3 str outright upsets in this series with the underdog covering the last 6. However, we think that underdog streak will end TY as we have been really impressed with the 2-1 Owls who had the largest win in sch'l hist LW beating Delaware St 59-0 (-39). It surpassed the previous 56-0 record set against Holy Cross in 1974 as the Owls piled up 19-7 FD and 351-93 yd edges. The 0-4 ATS Huskies have not been so impressive TY as LW they lost to USF 17-14 (+2) and the gm was very misleading as they were outFD'd 17-6 and outgained 271-132 as they benefitted from a 70-yd IR td w/05 left before getting up. While the Owls are in just their 2nd AF rose s/11, look for them to keep the hammer down TY if they get up early as LY's 21-pt blown lead has to still weigh heavy on their minds.

PITTSBURGH by 17 over Akron - UA has been shutout in their only two prior meetings incl a 35-0 loss (+12) the LTH ('98). The Zips last win on the road vs a non-conf opp was in '08 at Army 22-3, and they've dropped 11 str since by 23 ppg. While the Zips were embarrassed at home LW to a really good Marshall tm 48-17 (+10), keep in mind they lost by 40 at home to Ohio LY and then went on the road to N Ill and only lost by 7 as a 23.5 pt dog. Still they have been dominated at the LOS TY getting out-rushed 538-278 thru 3 gms while Pitt has outrushed their opp 1217-358 thru 4 gms! Pitt is off a 24-20 loss (-7) to Iowa as they blew a 10-pt HT lead but still had 24-17 FD and 435-311 yd edges. RB Conner managed 155 rush yds (5.3) despite being held in check for much of the 2H. He still has 699 yds thru 4 gms, which is well ahead of the pace set by Heisman Trophy winner Tony Dorsett in 1976. After a disappointing finish to LW's gm, look for the Panthers to rebound.

Iowa by 10 over PURDUE - The Boiler makers are 50-37-4 all-time on HC but have dropped B2B gms. IU is 6-2 SU/5-3 ATS in this series. From '97-'08, the HT was 9-1 SU/7-3 ATS but the visitor has now covered winning the L3 SU. LY IU led 38-7 when PU drove 75 yds for a td w/1:19 left. IU had a 28-12 FD edge 509-266 yd edge. The Hawks are on their 2nd str AG but do have a bye on deck while Purdue is on their 2nd of B2B home gms. Both tms are off impressive wins as Iowa predictably fared much better as an away dog after everyone threw them in the trash (0-3 ATS TY as DD HF), in their 24-20 upset (+6) win over Pitt. They were outFD 24-17 and outgained 435-311 but bkp QB Beathard replaced Rudock in the 3Q and went 7 of 8 for 98 yds giving their offense some life. That's 7 str gms the dog has covered in Iowa gms. The Boilers after playing ND tough like they always do kept that going LW w/a 35-13 win (-3) over S Ill as they jumped out to a 25-0 lead thanks to a couple of Salukis TO's. QB Etling had a 2nd str solid performance going 15-26-198-2-0. The Hawks are back to being a DD fav and we'll take the pts.

RUTGERS by 14 over Tulane - Tulane is 3-0 ATS in this series. They were -19 at home in their undefeated season of 1998 and won 52-24. They went into Rutgers in 2010 as a Big Dog POW and pulled an outright upset winning 17-14 (+17). In 2012 it was the season opener for each and Rutgers won 24-12 on the road but was -20.5. Tulane is on their 2nd straight AG and Rutgers who needs all the wins it can get, is just 2-7 ATS as a HF and are off of an emotional loss to Penn St, Navy's option and has UM on deck. Tulane's gm LW was a bit misleading as they trailed Duke 26-13 before the Blue Devils had 2 IR td's in the 4Q. Tulane QB Tanner Lee is really struggling comp just 47.4% of his passes w/an 8-9 ratio. However, on the other side, you have TO machine Gary Nova vs a ball-hawking Tulane secondary. One of the more shocking statistics from LW was the fact the Scarlet Knights outrushed Navy 284-171. Rutgers RB James had 96 yds on 7 carries before leaving the gm w/11:01 left 2Q (CS) and his replacement Goodwin had 104 but just 4.0 ypc. Tulane is all g 203 rush ypg (4.7) and look the Scarlet Knights to take advantage.

PENN ST by 7 over Northwestern - PSU has won 6 str vs NU by an avg of 15 ppg incl the L/gm ('12) 39-28 (-2). It was HC & PSU trailed 28-17 into the 4Q. In that Q the Nittany Lions outgained the Wildcats 186-30 scoring 22 unanswered. The Wildcats came in 0-3 ATS TY failing to cover their gms by 13.5 ppg but LW did get a 24-7 win (-26) over W Illinois. It was just their 2nd win in their L/11 gms and currently are on a 1-12 ATS streak. Penn St is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS under Franklin (1st Penn St coach to open 4-0 since Dick Harlow in 1915) and LW finally got their ground gm going in a 48-7 win (-27) over UMass. It was their most pts since a 52-3 win over E Illinois in 2009. After having just 227 rush yds combined in the 1st 3 gms, they had 228 LW and their rush D has been outstanding all g 50 rush ypg (1.8) and all'd just 3 LW. 1st AG of the ssn for the Cats but they are dangerous (13-6 ATS as AD) and keep in mind their 2 losses TY have come to the likes of NI and Cal (2 impressive tms so far TY).

TOLEDO by 13 over Central Michigan - This has been a series of streaks. UT won 10 in a row SU from '95-'04. CM then won 5 in a row SU from '05-'09. However, Dan Enos is 0-4 SU/ATS vs Toledo with SU losses by 11, 27, 23 and 21. LY was closer than the final w/UT (-11) having a 418-370 yd edge and the FD were even at 23. UT got a 22 yd FR td and led 21-14 at the half with CM having a 243-201 yd edge. LTH CM led 21-10 but all'd a 90/9pl td drive with :13 sec before HT. In the 2H Toledo scored on a PR td (to go up for good) & tacked on 2 IR td's to blow it open. CM offense has not been the same since they lost RB Rawls to susp (also All-MAC WR Davis has missed most of yr, CS) and LW they fell to Kansas 24-10 (+3). They did have a 18-15 FD edge but had 3 costly TO's. The Rockets, meanwhile, rebounded w/a 34-23 win (-14) over Ball St after B2B blowout losses. RB Hunt had his 4th str 100-ypd gm but did miss the 2H w/inj (CS). With many key players on the injury report, we'll take the HT by DD's here and wait to see if there is any value later in the wk.

KENTUCKY by 24 over Vanderbilt - This is VU's first road trip and they are coming off a physical game vs SCar while UK is fresh off a bye. UK had been 12-3 SU (11-4 ATS) from '96-'10 but VU has dominated the last 3 meetings winning by an avg of 33-5 with the avg line (-8) +145 ypg. LY VU was -11 at home and UK had a 166-79 yd edge at the half but trailed 9-6 incl blk'g an xp and returning it to VU. VU only led 15-6 and UK got a 45 yd pass to the VU13 but were called for a hold. They were int'd with 5:24 left and VU went 56/10 getting a td w/:47 left for the front door cover. The td came on 4&4 as they passed up a fg. TY will be a much different story as the Cats come in a perfect 3-0 ATS after their near upset of UF prior to the bye. We already used them TY on these pages as a HF in their 20-3 win (-13) over Ohio and a case could be made that the Bobcats are better than the Dores. Vandy comes in limping at 1-3 SU/ATS and LW despite a valiant effort vs SCar (lost 48-34, +21), QB Robinette was hurt again and true frosh Freeback had to take a majority of the snaps (Vandy led 14-0 at that pt). They also benefitted from 2 long KR td's. The Dores are playing their 1st road gm of the ssn and they are playing 31 freshman (most in nation). **This series brought us a 2010 5★ GOY winner as UK won 38-20. Will we go back to it again here?**

BOSTON COLLEGE by 6 over Colorado St - Just one prior gm in the '03 San Francisco Bowl, BC won 35-21 (never trailed). Colorado St is off a bye but does have to travel across the country and the Eagles are only off Maine after their big upset win over USC. BC after a slow start (10-10 midway thru 2Q) would cruise 40-10 (-22) as they had 28-6 FD and 549-139 yd edges. UF trans QB Murphy has been a revelation TY as he leads all QB's in the FBS w/500 rush yds (9.1). Outside of the Pitt gm, the Eagles have controlled the LOS as they have a 1345-393 rush yd edge on the ssn! The Rams are 2-1 SU/ATS as they beat UC Davis 49-21 (-24) prior to the bye. Their QB Grayson is never going to be confused as a run threat as he is off B2B 400-ypd passing efforts and has a 8-2 ratio on the yr. While both offenses should be able to score in this one, the BC D is all g just 272 ypg while the Col St D is all g 476 ypg and the Eagles are 6-1 ATS as a HF.

BUFFALO by 6 over Miami, Oh - While MU is 11-4 SU in this series, UB has won 4 of the last 6 and are on a 5-3 ATS run. The visitor is 5-2 ATS. LTH BU was -3' and UM got a td w/:23 left to tie the game at 24 but BU got a 47 yd KR and a 47 yd fg to win, 27-24. LY the situation set up well for MU as they were at home and BU had their MAC East Title game showdown vs BG on deck (but it was in 13 days). The gm was scoreless into the 2Q but the Bulls (-24) led 28-0 at HT and 44-0 until a MU pbg td w/3:04 left. While they are 0-4 SU, the Redhaws are much improved under 1st yr HC Martin as they are 3-1 ATS (only getting outgained by 36 ypg after getting outgained by 258 ypg LY!). LW they had a 1&goal at the Cincy 1 down 7 in the 4Q but lost yds on 3 str plays and then missed a FG as UC ran out the clock. UB is 2-2 SU/1-3 ATS and LW beat Norfolk St 36-7 (-26) as they had 22-10 FD and 431-215 yd edges. The dog in Miami, Oh gms TY is a perfect 4-0 ATS covering by 12 ppg and we look for it to be 0-5 ATS after this one.

TULSA by 7 over Texas St - Just one prior meeting in '03, Tulsa won 41-15 w/a 530-381 yd advantage (Texas St was then a FCS mt). The Golden Hurricane only led the Bobcats 7-3 at HT but used a 27 pt 3Q to pull away (227-64 yd edge). Tulsa has a huge situational edge here coming off a bye after an embarrassing 50-21 loss (E) at FAU 2 wks ago. Meanwhile, TSt is on B2B road gms after putting forth a max effort LW where they led Illinois 21-6 in the 2Q but then the Illini went on a 36-7 run. LY the Bobcats did not have to play B2B road games but in '12 they did so twice going 0-2 in the 2nd gm (lost 38-7 vs Utah St & 38-31 vs UTSA). The Golden Hurricane delivered a 4★ Key selection winner on these pages in their only role as a HF TY and we will not be afraid to go back to them here.

KANSAS ST by 24 over Ute - KSU is 1-1 incl a 40-7 win in the L/gm ('99). This is the 3rd str ssn KSU will play all their non-conf action at home. LW can be summed up as a huge missed opportunity for the Wildcats and the Big 12 in their 20-14 loss (+7) to Auburn. Their K after going 15-18 LY, missed 3 FG's incl 2 chipshot ones and they had 3 TO's incl an int that went off the hands of reliable WR Lockett in the EZ. UTEP is just 2-7 s/'06 after a bye but this looks like a different mt TY as they are a perfect 3-0 ATS and nearly pulled off an outright upset over B12 TT 3 wks ago. The ground gm has been the major reason why as they are avg 317 rush ypg (6.2) led by RB Aaron Jones (552, 7.9) but they are giving up 242 rush ypg (7.2) on D. While the Wildcats are a perfect 8-0 ATS off a SU loss the L/3 yrs, they did put forth a maximum effort LW.

AUBURN by 35 over Louisiana Tech - AU is 11-0-1 SU inc 8 str wins (all after '89). In the L/meeting ('09) it was tied 10-10 before an AU 49 yd FG on the last play of the 1H. In the 2H AU had a 336-104 yd edge w/ LT's deepest drive to the AU29. Auburn does have a couple extra days to prep off a Thurs Night vs Kansas St but do have a huge HG vs LSU on deck. LW they benefitted greatly from several KST miscues incl 3 missed FG's and 3 TO's and their incredible 13-gm ATS win streak is now over. Arguably one of the biggest shockers of the ssn so far came in LW's LT/NW St gm as the Bulldogs after B2B blowout upset wins was a 24-pt favorite, led from the beginning but NWSST scored off all 5 LT TO's incl 20 4Q pts and took the lead on a 47-ypd FG on the final play 30-27. LT had a 413-307 yd edge. While they have covered all 3 times as a dog TY, they did struggle at OU earlier TY, down 48-10, they got a garbage TD for the backdoor. Auburn won us a 3★ LPS 2 wks ago as a large HF (beat SJSST 59-13, -33) and we'll back them again here.

Bowling Green by 10 over MASSACHUSETTS - In their 2 MAC meetings, UMass' only pts came LY when trailing 28-0 to they went 71/10 for a 24 yd garbage td with 4:34 left in the game to avoid the shutout and get the backdoor cover (+26). LTH BG got the shutout 24-0 (-18). UM had just 6 FD's. There will be no shutout TY as what in the world has happened to the BG defense? After all g just 321 ypg LY, they are all g an FBS-worst 615 ypg TY and LW were steamrolled by Wisc 68-17 (+26) cashing us an easy 4★ Key selection on these pages as the Falcons all'd a B10 record 644 rush yds (10.7). The offense also bogged down as QB Knapke after setting several schl rec's in the upset win over Indy was just

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13-28-163-0-1.UMass is 0-4 SU TY and is the only school in the FBS to play 4 str Power 5 conf tms so far TY. After near B2B upsets over Colorado and Vandy, they were destroyed by Penn St LW 48-7 (+27). They will finally have a "true" HG here as McGuirk Stadium is on the UMass campus and this marks the 1st gm there s/'11's home finale. Look for them to give an inspired effort here but BG wins a shootout.

CALIFORNIA by 13 over Colorado - HT is a perfect 3-0 ATS. LTH ('10) Cal won 52-7 (-10) but only had a 356-241 yd edge. In '11 Cal beat CU 36-33 on the road (-6). LY at CU again, there were 35 mph winds but Laufau had a car high 364 yds passing (23-36). The Cal QB's seemed to be bothered by the wind (25-52-214) and the Buffs rumbled to a 41-24 win (-2). The Buffs cashed a 3★ on these pages LW for us but it wasn't easy as they won 21-12 (-8) over Hawaii despite having a 405-286 yd edge. The Bears are one of the most improved tms in the country TY and deserved so much better LW as they had a 45-30 lead with 3:45 left in the 4Q vs Arizona but allowed 3 td's incl a 47-ypd Hail Mary td pass on the final play in their 49-45 (+8) loss. QB Goff is avg 297 ypg (65%) w/a 10-2 ratio but it is the Cal run gm that has been the major surprise avg 187 ypg. This is CU's 3rd AG in 5 wks while Cal had a bye 2 wks ago. While it will be tough for the Bears to pick themselves up after LW's disappointment, they are clearly the superior squad here and will move to 4-0 ATS on the yr.

Rice by 3 over SOUTHERN MISS - Rice is 3-1 vs SMiss (all gms after '07) but the LTH ('11) lost 48-24 (+14). The Owls led 14-13 & 24-20 w/8:47 left 3Q but from that point they were outgained 307-65 all g 28 unanswered (punted 4 of their L/5 poss). HT is 3-0 s/'08. In the L/gm ('12), SM lost 44-17 (-3). Despite the 27 pt loss, SM had the yd edge (FD even). SM had 5 TO's that resulted in 14 pts and missed a 42 yd fg, lost 9 yds on a bad punt snap & were SOD at Rice 35. The Owls disappointed us LW as the defending CUSA champs who had won 9 str gms at home (6 by 17 pts or more) were beaten by CUSA newcomer ODU. A couple of key notes is that ODU got a td pass w/:22 left 1H to go up 28-10. Also Rice was playing w/out QB Jackson for a qtr and found themselves down 35-10 but rallied back to tie it at 42 before ODU kicked a FG on the final play. The Owls are 0-3 ATS as an AF and this is only their 4th time in that role since 2008. Meanwhile, SMiss has won 3 gms of their L/5 gms w/losses only to Miss St and Bama.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 10 over Missouri - This was MO's only reg ssn loss LY. SC st'd Dillon Thompson (15-27-222) but MO on its way to an almost perfect reg ssn led 17-0 into the 4Q. Connor Shaw came off the bench to hit 20-29-21 with scoring drives of 69, 69 and 63 yds. They got a td pass with :42 left to tie it and MO's chipshot 24 yd fg bounced off the upright in 20T. SC is now 2-0 SU/ATS at +117.5 ypg. MO does have a bye next wk but this is SC's only HG in a 4 wk span. LW the Gamecocks were in a letdown spot following the upset over UGA and they beat Vandy 48-34 (-21) as they all'd 2 long KR td's. Their 1st 3 opp's TY A&M, ECar and UGA have combined for just 2 losses with both coming at the hands of the Gamecocks. Mizzou played w/o DE Markus Golden LW (hamstring) as he had 4 sks and 6.5 fff's in the 1st 3 gms. Despite Mizzou's 145 yds in the 4Q to take a 27-24 lead w/2:20 left, Indy benefitted from a 4&6 pen to stay alive and get a TD w/:22 left in the 31-27 (-13) upset. SCar knows it can ill afford another conf loss (still have to travel to Aub) and we'll back them here as they move to 4-1.

NAVY by 7 over Western Kentucky - LY WKU scheduled a 15:00 option period at the end of each practice as they played both Army and Navy and did so in spring and Aug. A big key was Navy losing QB Keenan Reynolds in the 2Q due to injury and Navy had just 65 yds of offense with Hendrick at QB in the 2H. It was the only gm in the L/3 yrs that Navy has been held to under 297 yds. Reynolds was KO'd on a blindside hit by LB Jackson which didn't even draw a penalty flag so expect Navy to be playing with some legit revenge here. WKU does have the advantage of having a bye the week before Navy and like LY also has Army on the schedule. Navy had won the previous 2 gms 40-14 at WKU (-9) in '11 and 38-22 (-29) at home in '09. They had rushed for 373 and 410 in those two games but just 86 (2.5) LY in the 19-7 loss (+3). The Hilltoppers come in at 1-2 despite avg 607 ypg on offense. However, they are all g 509 ypg on D (avg score 47-41) and are off a 50-47 3 OT loss to MT prior to the bye. The Middies after a perfect 3-0 ATS start were upset at home to Rutgers 31-24 (-6) LW despite Reynolds ret'g from inj. Shockingly they were outrushed 284-171 and have a big gm vs AF on deck. In a gm of contrasting styles of play (Navy avg 345 rush, WKU avg 486 pass), we'll take the HT to rebound.

† Notre Dame by 14 over Syracuse - E Rutherford, 7th overall gm (series tied 3-3). ND last beat SU in '05 (34-10). In the L/gm ('08) SU won 24-23 (+19). SU trailed 23-17 w/4:58 left but went 68/8pl getting a 11 yd GW td pass w/:42 (ND missed 53 yd fg as time exp'd). As an FBS HC Brian Kelly is 15-5 SU after a bye and is 4-1 ATS here in the reg ssn. Kelly has never faced SU here but was 3-0 while at UC ('07-'09) winning each by 20+. The Irish are 3-0 but the wins have come over the likes of Rice, Mich and Purdue (combined 4-7) while they have a huge gm vs Stan on deck. They are outsourcing their opp by 26 ppg (+103 ypg). The diff has been QB Golsion who has 11 total td's and 0 TO's. The Orange come in off a 34-20 loss (-2) to Maryland as they had a 589-369 yd edge but were down 31-13 at HT. Their ground gm is avg 265 ypg (5.9) and QB Hunt became the 1st Orange QB to run for 100 yds (156) s/McNabb had 100 vs Miami in 1997. ND is all g just 99 rush ypg (2.9). The Irish usually shine in reg ssn neutral gms (10-1 SU/8-3 ATS) and they could have the crowd edge here.

† Texas A&M by 6 over Arkansas - 71st meeting. The game is being played at Arlington and of course, Jerry Jones is an Ark grad. A&M is on their 2nd of 3 str AG while Ark has a bye next week. They both played in the SWC but it was the Aggies 1st trip to Fayetteville s/'90 LY. AU had won 3 in a row from '09-'11 but have lost the L2 by margins of 58-10 (+13) at A&M in '12 and LY A&M was -14 on the road and at the half led 24-20. It was 45-33 when AU was SOD at the A&M 16 with 6:46 left. A&M last won 3 tr from 1941-'43. Both tms come in red hot (6-2 ATS) and we won playing on both LW as Arkansas cashed a 3★ Key selection on these pages in their 52-14 win (-13) over N Illinois while A&M crushed SMU 58-6 (-34) cashing a 2★ on these pages. It's going to be interesting to see which style of play wins out as the high-flying Aggies are avg 55 ppg and 613 ypg led by QB Hill who is avg 340 ypg (70%) w/a 13-2 ratio. On the other side, the Ground and Pound Hogs have rushed for 1,145 yds the L/3 wks and their QB Allen has an efficient 8-1 ratio. Will be interesting to see how the Aggies hold up defensively as they all'd 240 rush yds to Rice and while they only gave up 67 rush yds to SCar, the Gamecocks RB Davis was hurt and they had to go to the air early. We'll side with a Hogs tm that can shorten the gm.

USC by 13 over Oregon St - USC is 10-4 SU in this series but OSU is 8-4 ATS and there have been 4 outright upsets in the series L6Y. The HT is a strong 11-2 SU/9-4 ATS and OSU has not won in LA s/'60, losing 22 str trips. LY we won a Fri Night Marq on Under 52. LY USC led 24-14 and OST went 64/6 but missed a 26 yd fg. SC went 90/6 for a td to lead 31-14 after 3Q. OSU was int'd at the 3 and int'd at the 16 in the 4Q. The Trojans come in off a much needed bye as 2 wks ago travelling across the country off a big win over Stanford they were upset 37-31 (-17) to BC. The Beavers are off a 28-7 win (-10) over SDSt as QB Mannion became the all-time pass leader here (11,339). They had dominating 25-11 FD and 372-215 yd edges. Stanford by 4 over WASHINGTON - SU is fresh off a bye with a trip to ND on deck but UW only had GAST LW and has a bye on deck. SU is 7-2 SU/7-3 ATS in this series and the HT is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS. Two years ago when SU travelled here, they did not have a mobile BG. It was a Thurs night game and they led 13-3. UW went for it on 4&1 from their own 39 and got a 61 yd td run from Sankey on the last play of the 3Q to get back in it and pulled the upset, 17-13. LY the star of the game was SU WR Ty Montgomery who had a 99 yd KR to open and 290 all-purp yds. SU led 31-21 after 3Q's and UW finished with the yardage edge as UW had 170 yds in the 4Q. They were int'd at the 5, scored a td w/2:38 left and got the ball back and on 4&10 a controversial call had them SOD w/1:16 left. Despite playing a slightly tougher sked the Cardinal are +225 ypg TY while UW is just +133 ypg. LW in one of the biggest HT shocking scores we may see all yr, 5 td underdog Ga St led 14-0 over UW and had a 231-73 yd edge. The 2H was a little different as the Huskies outscored them 45-0 and had a 263-42 yd edge as Chris Peterson became the 1st UW coach to start 4-0 since Gil Dobie in 1908! Despite an earlier loss to USC, the Cardinal are #1 in the nation in scoring and tit D as they are all g just 4 ppg and 204 ypg. Cardinal pick up a road win.

Bud Foster's D also disappointed us for the 2nd wk in a row as after all g 502 yds to ECar, they gave up 250 rush yds to GT after holding them to less than 100 yds rush in each of the prev 2 gms. On the other side, the 2-1 SU/ATS Broncos have looked much improved TY and LW cashed a 3★ LPS Small College play for us (Small College plays 6-2 this year!) in their 45-14 win (-15) over Murray St. They piled up 30-15 FD and 605-305 yd edges and their star is true frosh RB Jarvion Franklin (225 lbs, good speed) who has amassed 542 rush yds (6.6) and 9 td's in just 3 gms! Clearly the Hokies need a win here especially w/a key ACC Coastal gm vs NC on deck, but they are just 6-13-1 ATS as a HF and we'll back the underdog Broncos again. VT by 18

Texas by 17 over KANSAS - UT is 11-0 SU in their B12 meetings and 8-3 ATS. LY UT was off big wins over Okla and TCU and was laying -27 at home. Leading 14-6 DL Whaley got a 40 yd FR td and UT got ahead of the spread, 35-6 w/9:17 left. KU got a td run w/3:39 left to get back to 35-13 capping a 75/9 drive. LTH UT was fortunate to escape with a win needing a 70/9 drive for a GW td w/12 left. UT is fresh off a bye but has Baylor on deck. Can't see why there will be any look ahead here though as this tm will need as many wins as it can get TY under 1st yr HC Strong. In their L/gm they fell to UCLA 20-17 (+7) but the offense did make some strides. KU on the other hand, is off a 24-10 win (-3) over CMich. It was tied at 10 after 3Q's. Look for the Horns to improve weekly with Swopes now in his 3rd start and an OL gaining exp and perhaps some health. Also can't have a lot of confidence w/a shaky Kansas off that is avg just 14 ppg and 333 ypg vs FBS competition TY and remember TX held NT in the opener to just 94 yds and 7 pts.

GEORGIA by 24 over Tennessee - UGA has won 4 in a row SU in this series but UT is 6-2 ATS. While the HT is 5-2 SU the visitor is 7-4 ATS. UGA's only 5 gm series win streak was from 1909-'24. UT has lost 3 str trips into Athens. LTH (UGA -14) the tms combined for 7 TO's. It was tied 30-30 at HT. UT trailed 51-44 w/8:56 left and their L/3 pass all ended in TO's (int at UGA36, fmb! at UGA35 & int at UGA48). LY UGA was coming off their big win over LSU and in a let down spot. The Bulldogs led 17-3 but UT would come back and take a 31-24 lead before UGA went 75/10 getting a 2 yd td pass w/05 left to force OT. In the OT UT's RB Howard reached out for the pylon but fmb'd into the EZ for a TB and UGA got the win. TY UGA is off a 66-0 (-39) win over Troy but UT is fresh off a bye. In their win LW the Bulldogs rushed for 367 yds (9.4), which is their most ever under HC Richter. RB Gurley moved up to 4th on UGA's all time rushing list and only had 6 carries so he'll be fresh if needed here. UT hasn't all'd a 100 yd rusher yet TY, but if needed, the best RB in the country will have no prob eclipsing triple digits. The Bulldogs are in must win mode now that they've started 0-1 in conf play and we'll call for them by 24, the same number OU beat UT by earlier TY.

MIAMI, FL by 8 over Duke - UM is in a Neb/GTech sandwich while Duke is off Tulane with a bye on deck. UM, however, is playing with legit revenge as they'd never lost to Duke (1st met '76). Duke had never topped 151 rush yds rush vs UM but rushed for 358 LY (6.9) as they were playing for a shot at the ACC Title and were at home. UM led 30-28 w/5:04 3Q, but on their next 4 poss didn't run a play in Duke territory & all'd 20 unanswered pts to lose 48-30 (-3) with the Duke fans charging the field after the game as the Blue Devils had also dropped 9 str home finales. In Duke's L4 trips here they have lost by 45, 10, 18 and 35 with the LTH ('11) losing 49-14 (+15). True frosh Hurricane QB Kaaya followed up his 342 yd passing gm 2 wks ago by throwing for 359 (67%, 3-2 ratio) LW at Neb but it wasn't enough as the rush D, which had only been allowing 83 ypg (2.0) was run over for 343 yds (6.4) incl 229 by AA RB Abdullah during the 41-31 (+7) loss. Duke enters full of confidence as their 47-13 (-16) win over Tulane extended their best start s/'94 (st'd 7-0). The Blue Devils forced 5 TO's & ret'd 2 int's for td's making it a bit of a misleading final. The Blue Devils have faced an FCS D, Troy's #125 D, Tulane's #93 D and Kansas' #85 D. Now they face the speedy Canes and Look for UM to get revenge here.

Florida St by 17 over NC STATE - FSU returns to the scene of the crime, 4 of the L5 times FSU has been ranked and faced an unranked NCS team, the Noles have lost incl the LTH ('12). FSU led 16-0 HT w/a 221-68 yd edge but let up in the 2H and NCS converted on 4th down 9x incl 3 on their final drive and got a td with :16 left to knock off the #3 ranked 'Noles 17-16 (+16). LY Bobby Bowden returned to campus and planted the spear at midfield prior to the game as they were playing with legit revenge. FSU dominated w/a 371-85 yd edge at HT leading 42-0 but once again let up in the 2H. FSU got a 31 yd td run with 2:19 left, 49-17 and ended at the NCS148 taking a knee. The line opened at -29' and kept climbing so when FSU won by 32, it was a push and even a loss on some spots. FSU is 1-3 SU/0-4 ATS here in Raleigh while the HT has won 5 str & is 7-1 SU/5-2 ATS. Since '95, NCS is 0-2 if facing a #1 FSU squad (losses by 60 & 31). FSU was fortunate to survive LW w/o their Heisman Trophy winning QB Winston (susp'd) as they won in OT 23-17 (-16) over rival Clemson. They had an 18-17 FD edge but were outgained 407-318. Backup QB Maguire was far from 'Winston-like' (21-39-305-12) but 'Famous Jameis' will return here. NCS is off a 42-0 shutout over FCS Presbyterian and are 4-0 SU for the 1st time s/'10. Despite the huge talent differentials here, tough to back the 0-3 ATS Noles who have had history of not showing up here.

OHIO ST by 21 over Cincinnati - This marks just the 5th meeting s/1932 between these two in-state school that are separated by just 109 miles. The Bearcats are 0-9 SU in Columbus incl losing 37-7 (+29) the LTH in '06 (also the L/meeting). OSU trailed 7-6 w/9:17 2Q. From that point on the Buckeyes held the Bearcats to 100 yds on 31 plays. The Buckeyes have won 10 str in this series and have held UC to single digits on 8 of those occasions. This is UC's road opener as they are just 2-8 SU s/'04 (1-5 ATS run). After opening the ssn with 2 str byes, they took care of in-state rival Toledo before surviving a determined Miami, Ohio squad LW 31-24 (-28'). ND trans QB Kiel followed up his historic 418 pass yd & sch! record tying 6 td performance in his collegiate debut with just 271 pass yds (4-2 ratio) LW as RedHawks HC Martin was Kiel's QB cch at ND and knew his strengths and weaknesses. The Buckeyes are off a bye and while they are 3-0 SU under Meyer in that situation they are just 1-2 ATS with both ATS losses coming LY as large DD fav's. OSU needed a statement win their last time out and got it in their 66-0 (-31) shutout over Kent. QB Barrett tied a sch! rec with 6 pass td's (Kenny Guiton '13) as the Buckeyes scored their most pts against an in-state foe s/1934 (76-0 over Western Reserve). OSU hasn't lost to an in-state opponent s/1921 (Oberlin College) & excluding their vacated wins in '10, they've beaten up on those foes by an avg 31 pt MOV.

UAB by 21 over Fiu - LY was the sch!s 1st meeting & UAB came in just 1-4 but was still fav'd by -6' at Fiu. UAB led 21-7 but Fiu got 2 scores before the half to make it 21-17. Fiu got a td w/2:41 left to tie the game but UAB went 70/11 and got a 28 yd fg with :10 left to pull out the road win 27-24. Fiu was only outFD'd 16-12 & outgained 336-205 in their 34-3 (+26') loss to Lville LW. True QB McGough struggled (5-12-47-0-2) and was rep'd after a 3Q fumble by Hilliard (8-12-70) who st'd 4 gms LY. This is Fiu's first AG & the Golden Panthers are just 2-10 SU/6-3 ATS in road openers (wins at YSU in '04 & Louisville in '11). These tms have pl'd the same type of sked's so far TY, but UAB is +127 ypg with a 41-24 avg score vs our #109 toughest sked, while Fiu is being outgained by 37 ypg and outscored 23-19 vs our #106 toughest sked. Fiu is improved in yr #2 under HC Turner, but the Blazers have shown they can rush the ball (339, 6.2 vs Troy) & pass the ball (435 vs Miss St) & Fiu has been run over by Pitt (321 rush, 5.9) before allowing 324 pass yds (2-0 ratio) vs Lville LW. Blazers roll!

MISSISSIPPI by 21 over Memphis - Memphis has lost 5 str in the series (L/2 by 24 ppg) incl a 41-24 (+7) loss the LTH ('08). Ole Miss got a 64 yd td pass but UM responded w/a 77 yd td drive, 7-7 w/3:07 1Q. From that point Ole Miss scored 27 of the next 30 into the 4Q. The last time these sch!s met was in '09. After 3Q's Ole Miss led just 17-7 but in the 4Q exploded for 28 pts & won going away 45-14 (-17). UM is 17-4 SU their L/20 non-conf HG's incl a 3-1 ATS run. The Tigers have a balanced offensive attack as 6-7 Soph QB Lynch has improved his compl rate to 66% (58% LY) while their running gm is avg 243 ypg (5.0) incl 164 (4.2) against UCLA's solid D-line. Ole Miss enters off a bye but does have a crucial home gm vs Bama on deck. Under HC Freeze the Rebels have done a solid job the wk before the Bama gm, going on the road to shutout Tulane 39-0 (-18) in '12 and taking down Texas in Austin 44-23 (+2) LY. Make it 3 for 3 here.

Utsa by 6 over FLORIDA ATLANTIC - First meeting. SA HC Coker returns to the sidelines in South Florida for the 1st time since his days as the Miami HC ('01-'06). The Roadrunners enter off a bye and have NM at home on deck. FAU meanwhile, is off a heart-breaking 20-19 (+3) loss at WY and has a short trip to rival FIU on deck. The Owls were outFD'd 17-16 & outgained 334-296 LW but appeared on the verge of pulling the outright upset up 19-17 with the ball at the WY11 w/2:09 left but normally reliable dual threat QB Johnson was hit and fumb'd on 1D giving the Cowboys a chance and they responded by driving down and kicking an 18 yd GW FG w/15 remaining. Both tms have pl'd demanding sked's early on but the Roadrunners have been more impressive being outgained by 107 ypg & outscored by 4 ppg despite playing our #2 toughest sked, while FAU is being outgained by 236 ypg & outscored by 15 ppg vs our #7 toughest sked.

ULM by 21 over Troy - Troy is 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS and haven't scored a td in the 2H vs an FBS foe TY! ULM has pulled out 3 str outright upset wins in the series & have won 4 of the L/5. Troy HC Blakeney summed up their last meeting by saying the difference of the game was "that God darn #15 brother" referring to ULM's QB Browning, who hit 21-31-354 and 5 td's in the 49-37 (+3) win on Halloween (Thurs night). The good news for the Trojans is that Browning has moved on, but the bad news is new ULM QB Thomas is a trans that began his car at CSU & was at NCS LY and when facing a similar pass D in Idaho earlier TY, threw for 384 yds. Troy has actually been favored their last 3 trips to ULM but have been upset each time as they lost 27-3 (-1) in '05, 31-30 (-10) in '08, and 28-14 (-16) in '10. ULM is off a bye with Ark St on deck while Troy is off SEC UGA but has a bye on deck. ULM has pl'd much better than Troy TY as the Warhawks are +24 ypg, being outscored 24-18 vs our #48 toughest sked while the Trojans are being outgained by 170 ypg & outscored by a 47-16 margin vs our #60 toughest sked. This is the 1st time in 10 meetings (L/17 yrs) that ULM is the favorite in this series and we think it is deserved!

UTAH by 17 over Washington St - This is not only the P12 opener, but also HC for Utah and the HT has covered all 3 conf meetings. LTH WSU trailed 49-0, but avoided the shutout with a td with no time left & Leach 2'd his players effort for the game and made the unique move of sending out the entire O-line and D-line to face the media after the game to answer questions about their performance. LY WSU jumped out to a 21-0 lead (-1) at home and was up 33-20 at the half (291-195). WSU got a 71 yd td pass w/4:42 left, 49-37 and became bowl elig. 4 of the L5 series meetings have been decided by 12 or more. Wazzu nearly pulled a huge upset vs Oreg LW, losing 38-31 (+23). They were tied 31-31 4Q, but all'd the Ducks to score the GW td w/5:33 left. The Cougars actually had a 29-22 FD edge & were outgained by just 2 yds (501-499). Utah went on the road LW and pulled the outright upset over a downtrodden Mich program 26-10 (+5) despite being outFD'd 19-13 & outgained 308-286. The Utes recorded their FBS leading 3rd kick/punt return td when Clay ret'd a punt 66 yds for a td in the 2Q. Both tms off max efforts, and we'll side with the HT.

Boise St by 13 over AIR FORCE - This is BSU's 1st trip to AF and just the 3rd overall meeting (BSU 2-0 SU/0-2 ATS). LY on a Friday night BS was -23' at home and were 10-10 on 3rd down conv's! The 1H was even as each team scored every time they had the ball. AF settled for 24 and 33 yd fg's and trailed 21-17. BSU opened the 3Q with a td and AF went 76/13 but again settled for a 24 yd fg, 28-20. BS went 80/7 for a td w/8:12 left. After an int, the Bronco's went 47/6 for a td for the 42-20 final. In the only 2 gms ('11 & LY) the Broncos have held the Falcons to 51 & 75 yds below their ssn rushing avg. AF is off a bye & has a home gm with rival Navy on deck. BSU easily cashed our Inside Information Marquee for us by dominating ULL 34-9 (-17) LW. The Bronco's had 24-14 FD & 499-241 yd edges and have to travel to Nevada next. After throwing just 5 int's all of last ssn, BSU QB Hedrick already has 5 TY, but look for him to improve upon his 5-5 ratio against a Falcon pass D that is allowing 348 ypg vs FBS foes w/a 5-1 overall ratio TY.

LSU by 42 over New Mexico St - In the schools only prior gm ('96), LSU won 63-7. The Tigers had a 56-0 lead into the 4Q w/31-14 FD and 598-278 yd edges. Under Miles, the Tigers are 38-0 SU in non-conf reg ssn gms. LSU QB Jennings is ? (undisclosed inj), but he was compl just 51.3% of his passes TY & QB Harris' comeback attempt fell just short in the 34-29 (-9) loss to MSU LW, snapping LSU's 14 gm series winning streak. After compiling B2B shutouts, the Tigers D was thrashed for 570 ttl yds, incl 302 on the ground (most rush yds all'd s/'10 (Aub 440)). NMST lost their 3rd str Rio Grande Rivalry gm LW 38-35 (+3) despite having 29-24 FD & 507-499 yd edges. NMST has lost 20 str vs ranked foes by an avg score 47-10 (L/win in '99 at Arizona St 35-7). After being held to just 89 rush yds (2.5) LW, LSU RB's will be able to run wild against an Aggie rush D allowing 299 ypg (6.1) TY. Finally NMST has been shutout at least once in 7 of L/10 yrs & can the LSU D hold it's 3rd opponent in it's L4 gms w/o any points?

NEBRASKA by 21 over Illinois - Cornhuskers are 8-2-1 SU vs the Illini with the last series loss in 1924 but the L/meeting prior to LY was in 1986. Conf opener for both tms. IU is 2-18 SU/7-12-1 ATS & are on a 1-4 ATS run in B10 openers. Nebraska is 9-3 SU/6-6 ATS hosting Big 10 opp's since joining the league in 2011. IU's D isn't at all improved after allowing 34 ppg the L2Y's they're allowing 37.7 vs FBS foes TY. Neb is coming off a much needed 41-31 (-7) win over Miami, FI, their 1st gm against a power-5 conf tm TY. AA RB Abdullah finished with 229 rush yds (6.5), even more impressive considering the 'Canes entered the gm allowing just 2.0 rush ypc. LY in their only recent meeting, we used NU as a 4★ Key Selection on these pages and the #1 Econo Club Play. The Huskers dominated the game with 335 rush yds (6.7). NU led 23-5 at the half with a 259-174 yd edge and went 75/4 on their first drive of the 3Q and won easily, 39-19 (-7) with IU going 75/12 for a garbage td with :57 left. IU had all they could handle w/TXST LW, falling behind 21-2Q before rallying to win 42-35 (-14). They were outFD'd 26-21 & only had a 485-475 yd edge. Sked edge does go to them however, as they have a home date w/PU on deck while NU after hosting Miami LW, travels to Mich St next. Despite the situational edge for the Illini, we'll back the HT here.

4★ Atlanta by 20 over MINNESOTA - The Falcons not only get extra rest after destroying TB they get to face a rookie QB in his 1st start with over a full half of film for them to work with. Teams off a DIV win of 21 or more are on a 14-5 ATS run and the Vikings pass defense showed a glimpse of its real nature LW. Brees aired it out for 293 yds (77%) with 2 TD's and while Ryan struggled at CIN its a forgivable offense. MIN was forced to put Bridgewater into the game after Cassel (foot) was KO'd and while his QBR was decent (83.3) look deeper as he had a 7.5 ypa (60%) with 47% of his 150 yds coming on 2 bad plays by the NO def. After his 1st drive Bridgewater's Vikings had 7 FDs and 119 yds on 4 real drives. Already without Peterson, MIN saw TE Rudolph, RG Fusco and stud WLB Greenway leave with injuries along with slot CB Robinson. Look for the Falcons to use their deep WR unit to jump out to an early lead and put the pressure on a rookie QB here.

3★ SAN FRANCISCO by 10 over Philadelphia - PHI is the 1st team to go 3-0 despite being down by 10 or more in each game. This is a poor spot for the Eagles as they are now down 4 OL after losing Ctr Kelce LW and now have to go cross country after a shootout vs WAS. Foles was impressive (325 yds 67% 3 TD) LW but took a big hit late in the game and now has to go against an physical SF defense that needs to makeup for their embarrassing effort vs CHI. Instead of playing at home or in a dome they now have to play on a slow grass field vs a SF team that is used to high powered pass offenses like GB, NO and ATL. SF caught a break LW as ARZ started Stanton and Kaepernick used his mobility to exploit a thin ARZ defense but SF went away from the run in the 2H (16 yds 2.3). Only 1 of their 5 2H drives went over 28 yds (3 FD) and it resulted in a blocked FG. SF did fairly well with 3 WR sets to make up for not having TE Davis (ankle) and they are the healthier team that is 2-0 ATS after B2B losses in Harbaugh's tenure with a 31-9 avg score and are the play vs a depleted PHI offense.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ NY JETS by 6 over Detroit - The Lions clearly have the overall talent edge here but they are 5-15-1 ATS on the road and 4-13 ATS off a SU win. In his L5 road games Stafford only has a 78.7 QBR with a 51% comp rate (1-4 ATS) with the defense giving up an 87.4 QBR with a 60% comp rate and 9-3 ratio. The Jets are off B2B high caliber offenses vs GB then CHI on MNF and won't be overly intimidated as while their secondary is iffy they have a standout front 7. In their L6 games the Jets have out rushed foes 170 (4.8) to 99 (4.2) as they've taken the pressure off Geno Smith with an avg of 35 rushes per game. DET's win over GB is a bit misleading as they had a 40 yd fumble return for a TD, forced a safety, only had 3.0 ypc on the ground and had 3 TO's which are usually gamebreakers vs Rodgers. DET may have played this venue 3 Wks ago but this is an unfamiliar foe with the homefield edge and getting points for the play.

Miami by 3 over OAKLAND - London - The Raiders are 0-3 SU/ATS prior to their bye losing by an avg score of 30-4 and while they've only been outgained by 61 ypg they've avg'd -3 TO's each game. They took the Patriots to the brink LW getting down to the NE 6, having a game tying TD nullified by a penalty then being intercepted on the 11 with 59 sec left. OAK's defense stayed on the field for 71 plays and was outgained 304-191 prior to their final drive. The coaching staff has Carr on a short leash with only 1 pass over 20 yds vs NE and his ypa of 4.7, 6.3, 5.1 simply aren't going to scare defenses with a rush game that has yet to have a player earn 60 yds in a game so far. MIA gave up 174 yds (4.2) to a Chiefs team that rested RB Charles, lost the TO edge (2 TO's into 7 pts) and was hit for a safety. MIA is 0-4 ATS prior to their bye (27-18 avg score) and with Tannehill yet to hit an 80 QBR on the season and their LB's being a major issue we'll only call for them by a FG.

Green Bay by 6 over CHICAGO - The Packers own this series with a 9-3 SU/ATS mark winning by a 24-16 avg score. Rodgers avg's 236 ypg (68%) vs CHI with a 21-8 ratio. He now gets a team off B2B primetime road games with a dinged up secondary (top CB Tillman IR) after losing to another Div team that they used to dominate. GB's attempt to be balanced offensively may be working against them as after just 2 games with a ypa of 6.5 of less they have 2 already TY and Rodgers did not have a completion over 20 yds LW. GB has given up a whopping 50% 3rd Dn conversion rate so far but their pass rush of Matthews/Peppers gets a CHI OL down 2 starters off long road trips. CHI still had rush def issues (161 ypg 5.3 LY) giving up 193 (5.9) vs BUF and 129 (4.8) vs SF. We'll call for the road team here by 2 FG's and wait for the line after the Bears MNF game.

HOUSTON by 7 over Buffalo - The Bills hit the road after thumping MIA in a highly emotional game then coming back to earth against SD. This is a mini reunion game with Mario Williams and Fitzpatrick vs their former teams. BUF was beaten worse than the final score/stats as SD stopped caring early in the 4th Qtr and owned a 20-13 FD/ 310-227 yd edge. The Bills are playing small ball with Manuel (63% 7.0 ypa) to reduce TO's but that makes them predictable. The Texans showed the after effects of playing both sides of the country in LW's as they committed 3 TO's with a blocked punt for 17 pts. HOU couldn't execute their offense with Foster (hamstring) out and gave up 193 yds (4.6) on the ground. We side with a deeper home team with a manageable line vs a Bills team that hasn't been on the road in 3 weeks with a system that plays to the Texans strengths up front.

INDIANAPOLIS by 10 over Tennessee - The Titans are off B2B embarrassing efforts losing at home vs DAL and were stomped LW vs CIN. TEN only had 2 drives over 45 yds missing a FG and their 6 play/80 yd drive came in garbage time with CIN up by 33. Their effort vs KC looks like a mirage with Locker fielding a 60.2 and 41.9 QBR the L2W and the defense giving up 220 yds (5.1) and 116 yds (3.7) on the ground. IND 8-0 SU/ATS vs DIV foes with Luck avg 246 ypg (59%) with a 20-8 ratio in all his matchups vs the AFC South. IND doesn't get a lot of line value after thumping JAX LW as they had a 509-160 yd edge before letting up in the 4th Qtr. Still, they have a big edge with Luck in a system he's comfortable in and while 1-2 they were very competitive vs DEN and had their chances to beat PHI if not for their share of defensive mistakes. Look for the Titans to keep this close early but for the Colts to pull away with the win late in the game with a better QB that's comfortable in his system.

BALTIMORE by 1 over Carolina - BAL is 1-6 ATS as a NDIV fav and for the 2nd time in 3 games we've seen them struggle vs physical defensive teams that can run the ball. Vs CIN they struggled to get the offense going with the Bengals all over Flacco and CIN moved the ball effectively despite settling for FG's all day. CLE had 3 separate drives of 80 yds for 3 TD's and if not for FG blunders would have won the game. BAL has an intangible edge with Steve Smith vs his former team and will be able to fill the

defense in on how to deal with Newton though BAL has yet to pull in an int TY. They are still allowing a very respectable 89 ypg (3.7) on the ground which plays to CAR's strength. BAL was taken to the limit LW by a scrappy CLE team and lost TE Pitta (hip) for the year as the offense hasn't looked comfortable in the new Kubiak offense.
