## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ USC over ARIZONA ST** - ASU has beat USC in B2B yrs for the 1st tm s/'96-'97 and now goes for 3 str. ASU is off a 34-10 (-27) home win over NM last Friday. RB Richard rushed for 104 (6.9) & had 151 (37.8) rec to become the 1st FBS pl'r w/over 100 rush & 150 rec in a gm s/'11 (NT RB Lance Dunbar). The Sun Devils only led 10-0 at HT and finished with 449-295 yd & 19-15 FD edges. After facing B2B option offenses, ASU will welcome a pro style offense. That could come with a price however as USC is off a home loss to Stanford 41-31 (-9') and playing with revenge this week. USC appeared in control up 21-10, 2Q but could not slow down the efficient SU offense. The HT is 4-1 SU in this series and should be 5-0 as LY USC had the game locked up until allowing a Hail Mary on the final play of the game. USC was -12 at home and led 34-25 with 3:00 to go. LTH USC led 21-20 early 3Q but all'd 28 str and lost 62-41 (+4). This is an extremely important gm for the Trojans in the P12 South Division and USC will get a statement win this week.

**FORECAST: USC BY 14**

**3★ AUBURN over Mississippi St** - Auburn is off a 45-21 (+6) loss at LSU. Aub gave up 411 rush yds incl a couple that made the highlight reel! MSt also lost to LSU in wk 2 but by a much closer score of 21-19. LW MSt played an FCS tm which may have given them extra time to prepare for this one. LY Auburn never led MSt as they fell behind 21-0 in the 1Q but did get within 8 on two separate occasions. Aub was only outgained 469-441 as each team turned the ball over 4 times (34 comb pts off TO's). MSt is just 3-11 SU vs Aub & the visitor has dropped 4 straight. LTH neither tm was ranked & after trailing 11-0, MSt took a 20-17 lead but allowed a 88/12pl drive capped off by an 11yd GW td pass w/10. Auburn is on an 0-8 ATS run ATS, while MSt is 10-5-1 ATS vs Conf foes, but we aren't afraid to go with the revenge seeking Tigers this week. We have vent against Aub as DD fav's in all 3 of their gms TY and are 3-0. Now however, as just a single digit fav and the nat'l media tearing into them, we believe that the Tigers will prevail by DD.

**FORECAST: AUBURN BY 10**

**3★ WEST VIRGINIA over Maryland** - While MD has won 3 str road openers, they're also on a 3-1 ATS run in that role. However, WV has won 8 of the L/9 meetings SU in this series, going 6-2 ATS. LY saw muffed punts, blk'd punts/fg's & a PR td. WV led 28-6 1H but after a MD 69-yd PR td it was tied at 37 w/9:43 left. WV took over on their 5 w/2:35 & nailed a GW 47-yd fg as time exp'd (65/13pl drive). WV was +3 and did have 694-447 yd and 33-16 FD edges. MD has dropped 4 str trips here by 12 ppg incl a 31-21 loss the LTH ('12). MD never led and w/their gm 14-14 mid-2Q all'd 17 str pts until getting a td w/7:25 left. WV comes in fresh off a bye after a 41-17 (-32) win over FCS Liberty. After getting upset at home by BG, the Terps responded with a solid 35-17 (-7) win over USF. QB Rowe made his 1st start s/'13 & hit 21-33-297 with 4 td passes, but he did throw 3 ints. MD had 411-300 yd & 18-16 FD edges. The Terps have their B10 opener at home vs Michigan on deck while WV travels to OU for their B12 opener next week, so there's no real sked edge on either side. The Mountaineers may be on an 0-10 ATS run off a bye in the reg ssn, but we aren't afraid to go with them as we feel that streak will come to an end this week and WV is the far superior team and is at home.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ WISCONSIN over Hawai'i** - UH takes another trip inland TW vs a B10 Tm. In Wk 2, UH was shutout by OSU 38-0 (+41). L/gm these schools met in '09 on the Islands and the Badgers dismantled the Rainbow Warriors 51-10 (-12). UW led 37-3 w/under 5 min to play ending the gm w/ 554-214 yd & 26-14 FD edges. LW UW won over Troy 28-3 (-34') and held a 401-255 yd edge. Hawaii will have traveled round-trip 17,334 miles in a 3 Wk span after returning home from road trips to Columbus, OH & Madison, WI. UW is on a 2-5 run ATS, while Hawai'i is 4-1 as a DD Dog. Those technical edges don't scare us however, as this is 5★ weekend and we've had success backing the Badgers over the years, delivering us a lot of 5★ winners. Will Wisconsin be our September 5★?

**FORECAST: WISCONSIN BY 35**

**2★ Missouri (+) over KENTUCKY** - MO is a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS in this series as SEC rivals. LTH the Tigers trailed 3-0 until a td w/1:20 1Q. From that mark they rolled to a 28-3 HT lead and UK never got closer than 18 the entire 2H as MO (-14) won 48-17. LY the Wildcats never led and w/7:23 left trailed 20-3. UK did go 80/12pl cutting the deficit to 10 w/3:26 left, rec'd the ensuing inside but on 48-1 from the MO21 were SOD at the w/1:54 left and lost 20-10 (+8). Mizzou is off just a 9-6 (-21') home win over UConn, becoming the 1st SEC team to win scoring fewer than 10 pts s/'11 (LSU over Bama). The Tigers had just 270 tll yds & 16 FD's & trailed 6-2 at HT. KY is off a 14-9 (+3') home loss to Florida, their 29th str loss to the Gators. The yds & FD's were nearly even, but QB Towles was just 8-24-126-0-2. Kentucky is on a 5-12-1 ATS run in conf gms and has failed to cover its L/4 HG's, while MO is 4-1 as an AF. Mizzou also comes in with the nations longest winning streak on the road, having won 11 str. Now Mizzou is getting points against a team that is still learning how to win. We'll gladly take the 2X defending SEC East champs getting points this week.

**FORECAST: MISSOURI BY 16**

**2★ ULM (+) over ALABAMA** - Bama comes to this gm needing to wash off a rare home loss. LW Bama was a 6 pt HF vs Ole Miss in a revenge game. Ole Miss scored on 2 long passes incl a 66 yd prayer that somehow deflected into the WR's hands (QB just tossed ball up w/o looking). Bama actually had 503-433 yd & 29-16 FD edges but also had 5 TO's (3 ints & 2 fumb incl the opening KO) and the flukey TD pass was too much to overcome. Bama was also SOD twice inside the Ole Miss 35. ULM, meanwhile, has had an extra week to prepare for Bama as they're off a bye. Prior to that, ULM won over an FCS tm, so they're essentially off 2 str byes. This will be the 2nd trip to SEC country this ssn for ULM. In wk 1 ULM lost at Georgia 51-14 (+31). Believe it or not, the LTH ('07) ULM pulled a 21-14 outright upset despite being outgained 409-282, as they were +5 TO's. Bama is 0-4 ATS off a SU loss the L4Y's and while we aren't calling for another outright upset in this series, we do think that the Warhawks can keep it close as HC Berry has the offensive artillery to get a couple of late scores

## OTHER GAMES

### SEPT 24 (THUR)

**Cincinnati at MEMPHIS** - Revenge gm for UC. Cincy did dominated this series but after LY's SU/ATS loss they are now 5-2 SU and 6-1 ATS. The last time Cincy traveled here was a Wed night game in '13 and UC was -2' and won 34-21. UC had just a 14-7 lead at HT despite a 218-58 yd edge. LY UC was -3'. UC suffered its worst home loss s/'05 as UM led by DD from the 6:10 mark of the 1Q on. UM had a 610-352 yd edge, their 3rd most yds in a game s/'84 (ironically also vs Cincy). UC is off a 37-33 (-20) win at Miami, Oh as QB Kiel suffered a conc early 3Q and backup QB Moore turned the ball over 4X in the 4Q. The Bearcats scored the GW td with 1:13 left. Cincy did have 545-448 yd & 33-17 FD edges. UM is off a come from behind win at BG 44-41 (-3). Down 41-34, UM tied it early 4Q, then took the lead with a fg with 7:35 left. The Tigers were outgd 579-541, but did have a 28-24 FD edge. Get our Thurs night Marquee for just \$12 using your Northcoast Sports VIP Debit card.

### SEPT 25 (FRI)

**Boise State at VIRGINIA** - First meeting. Virginia has not suffered 4 str losing ssn s/1969-78 when they went 10 str yrs. They survived FCS William & Mary LW, winning 35-29. The Hoos were outgd 373-371 & outFD'd 21-15. L5Y Boise has traveled east and beat #10 VT (33-30, '10), #19 Georgia (35-21, '11), Toledo (40-15, '11) & Conn LY (38-21). They lost to #13 Mich St (17-13) & to #18 Miss LY (trailed 7-6 in 4Q). Boise comes in on an extra day of rest after their 52-0 win over FCS Idaho St last Friday. Stg QB Finley was inj'd and Brett Rypien became the 1st Boise true frosh to play QB s/'93 (Tony Hilde). Rypien led scores on all 4 of his possessions.

**Stanford at OREGON STATE** - OSU has lost 5 str in this series. LY OSU tied the gm 7-7 on a 5/1pl "drive" after a int w/2:03 1Q. SU went on to score 31 unanswered until a bgb td w/3:54 left. OSU had just 78 yds thru F3Q's. LTH SU was -4' and won 20-12. OSU down 8 had a 1st & gl at the 7 but had 4 inc passes, the last with :01 left. SU rallied from a 28-24 late 3Q deficit to defeat USC 41-31 (+9') LW. The Cardinal had 474-427 yd & 26-20 FD edges. OSU is off a 35-21 (-7') win over SJSt after scoring 21 unanswered 2H pts. The Beavers had 438-253 yd (303-104 rush edge) & 24-14 FD edges. SU is 6-2 SU/5-2-1 ATS in this series and the home team is 6-2 SU (but SU has covered their last 2 here), 4-2-1 ATS. SU is 18-6 SU in P12 AG's. Sked edge favors the Beavers as SU is on a 2nd str road game and fresh off USC with Ariz on deck while OSU has a bye on deck. Stanford played NW Sept 5, while OSU pl'd Mich Sept 12 so we wonder if Shaw & Harbaugh have exchanged scouting info as they were former colleagues. ### SEPT 26 (SAT)

**MICHIGAN by 4 over BYU** - Last/only gm was in '84. Legendary HC LaVell Edwards just completing a 13-0 ssn w/a 24-17 Holiday Bowl win over Michigan to take home the National Championship. BYU's best ssn in program history. UM is 22-5 SU the L6Y vs non-conf opp's in the reg ssn. UM had 377-235 yd & 17-15 FD edges in their 28-7 (-35) win over UNLV LW. UNLV didn't score until the 4Q. RB Isaac had a car high 114 (14.2l) rush yds. After winning two emotional gms TY, BYU is off an emotional loss at UCLA 24-23 (+16'). The Cougars led 10-3 at HT & 20-10 4Q, but all'd the game deciding td w/3:21 left. The yds were nearly even, but BYU had a 26-18 FD edge and was +2 TO's. They shut down UCLA true frosh QB Rosen (11-23-106-1-3), but couldn't slow down the Bruins rush attack (all'd 296, 7.8). BYU is on an 11-3 run as an AD, but this is the 3rd road trip in 4 wks to a P5 team.

**EASTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Army** - Army is 5-1 SU and 3-2 ATS in this series but the home team is 4-1 ATS. They last met in '13 and Army was -7' at home and rushed for 513 yds (Terry Baggett school record 304) and won going away 50-25. Army's only loss came in their last trip here in '12 (-2, 48-38) with EM having a 577-478 yd edge despite their QB rushing for 212 yds. Army is off a 17-14 (+5) home loss to WF. After leading 7-0 at HT, Army tied the gm at 14 mid 4Q, but all'd a 47 yd fg w/no time left. The Black Knights were outgd 346-240 & outFD'd 19-11, but were +3 in TO's. EM scored the first 17 pts but then all'd 28 unanswered in their 28-17 (+5) home loss to Ball St. They were outgd 472-319 & outFD'd 26-12. Army is just 2-19 ATS on the road, but EM is on an 8-18-1 overall ATS run.

**Nevada by 3 over BUFFALO** - The Bulls lost the only prior meeting with the Wolfpack 38-13 (+16) on the road in '04. Buffalo's only other game vs a current MW team was a 49-24 loss to San Diego St in the 2013 Idaho Potato Bowl. Nevada has played 3 non-conf, non P5 teams on the road the L5Y and won them all (BYU 42-35 and UNLV twice 42-37 & 44-26). The Wolf Pack are off a 44-27 (+34) loss at A&M. While Nev was outgd 535-359 & outFD'd 30-19, they did cut the deficit to 14 early 4Q. Buf is off a midleading 33-15 (+2) win at FAU. The Bulls had as many fumble ret yds as pass yds (105), scoring 3 def td's. They were outgd 487-290 & outFD'd 27-13, but were +4 in TO's. This is a rare trip to the East for NV but NV HC Brian Polian was an asst at UB in '98 then again '01-03 (4Y). NV's off 2 P5 tms and has their conf opener on deck while UB is off B2B AG's and has their MAC opener (also homecoming) on deck.

**MICHIGAN ST by 31 over Central Michigan** - LTH ('11) the Chippewas were crushed 45-7 (+21'). MSU was seeking revenge from a prior '09 loss. CM only trailed 7-0 into the 2Q but 3 huge TO's on consecutive poss resulted in 17 pts & MSU led 24-0 mid-2Q. Back in '09 CM upset Mich St 29-27 (+14). Dantonio has left nothing to chance the last 2 meetings with Mich St winning in '11 and 41-7 (-19) in '12. We won a 2H on these pages LW going against Sparty in their 35-21 (-25) win over AF. MSU was actually outgd 428-324 & outFD'd 24-22, but benefitted from +3 TO's & QB Cook tied his car high w/4 td passes. CM is off a 30-27 (+8) OT loss at Syracuse. The Chippis dominated with 539-329 yd, 30-11 FD & 39:06-20:54 TOP edges. CM is 2-6 as a dog of 20+ pts, but did cover earlier TY vs OkSt in that role. MSU is 8-3 as a DD fav (0-2 TY) and is on an overall 14-8 ATS run as a fav. CM didn't hire its HC until after signing day, but it hasn't mattered as they are 3-0 ATS (MSU is 0-3 ATS). MSU will be happy to look ahead to this after dealing with Oreg & the option in B2B weeks and while they do have their B10 opener on deck, it's against lowly Purdue. CM is travelling for B2B weeks and has their MAC opener next week vs NIU.

**NEBRASKA by 17 over Southern Miss** - Cornhuskers are 4-1 SU in this series incl a 56-13 win in the L/gm ('13). NU led 35-6 at HT w/a 233-168 yd edge. The difference in the gm was two 1H (43 & 22) IR td's. NU's only loss vs SM was in '04 when NU was in year 1 of a pro-style offense (switched from option attack). Neb came back from a 23 pt 4Q deficit to tie Miami, but then lost in OT 36-33 (+3). The FD were even and Neb was outgd 511-462 and were -2 TO's. SM is off a 56-50 (+3) win at TXSt as RB Richard had a car high 230 yds & 4 td's. After leading 21-3 early 2Q, the Golden Eagles were down 25-21 at HT. SM had a slight 613-591 yd edge, but were outFD'd 29-22. This is homecoming weekend for Neb and they are on a 10-5 ATS run as 7+ fav's. Both have their conf openers on deck with NU travelling to Illinois while SM returns home vs NT. SM is 3-0 ATS TY covering vs Miss St while Neb has dropped 2 of its F/3 on the final play of the gm.

**HOUSTON by 17 over Texas State** - The Bobcats are 4-1 SU in this series incl a 30-13 (+36') win LTH ('12) as we had them as our Big Dog POW on the PPH and they pulled the massive upset. The gm marked TXSt's inaugural contest as a full-fledged FBS program. UH never led and their only td came on a 64-yd pass, trailed 14-10 into the 2Q. TXSt held UH to 191 yds the L3Q's. Prior to 2010 they L/met in '48. Houston is fresh off a bye after pulling off a 34-31 (+13') upset at L'ville in their L/gm. The Cougars had a 462-395 yd edge. TXSt is off a 56-50 (-3) home loss to SM as they all'd 613 tll yds. From 2005-'06 Houston HC Herman was the Bobcats OC, so he is familiar with the program. The Cougars are avg 545 tll yds inc 249 (4.9) rush while Hermans prev tm he was the OC at (defending nat'l champ Buckeyes) are struggling mightily on the offensive end. The Bobcats are on a 6-2 ATS run overall and are 4-1 as an AD. UH is 8-2 ATS off a bye.

**Virginia Tech by 17 over EAST CAROLINA** - VT is 10-2 SU in this series but is in revenge mode as LY EC (+9) caught them off its huge win over Ohio St. Tied at 21, EC went 65/3pl getting a GW td w/16 left (led 21-0 into 2Q). The last time EC upset VT was '08 and the next yr VT came into EC and won 16-3 (-13) and had a 379-277 yd edge. EC last won 2 str in '91-'92. EC is off a 45-21 (+5') loss at Navy. Despite the 24 pt loss, the Pirates were only outgd 456-405 & outFD'd 28-25. VT is off a 51-24 (-5') win at Purdue. The Hokies blk'd their 67th punt under HC Beamer. St'g QB Motley hit 15-24-220-2-0 in his 1st road start as VT had 471-265 yd, 20-9 FD & 38:11-21:49 TOP edges. EC HC McNeal is 6-3 ATS as a HD and VT used to be great on the road but is just on a 2-7 ATS run as an AF, counting LW's win in that role.

**PENN ST by 21 over San Diego St** - First meeting. PSU is off a 28-3 (-9) win over Rutgers as RB Barkley rushed for 195 yds & 2 TDs. PSU had a 471-294 yd edge, but was outFD'd 20-17. SDSt is off a stunning 34-27 (-17) OT home loss to South Alabama. The Aztecs were outgd 511-305 & outFD'd 23-14 as they couldn't hang onto a 17-3 late 2Q lead. HC Long said he recently saw a breakdown of PSU's sked on ESPN in which they were given an 84% chance of beating SDSt. This is just SDSt's 3rd trip to the East coast since 1991 and they are 1-1 SU/ATS. Sked edge favors PSU as the Aztecs return home to face FSU next week, while the Nittany Lions have a home date vs Army (haven't left the state of PA yet this year). SDSt is 2-14 SU vs the B10. Technical edges highly favor PSU as they are 10-5 ATS vs non-conf and 12-7 as a HF, while SDSt is just 8-15 ATS vs non-conf and 2-4 as an AD.

**Bowling Green by 4 over PURDUE** - The BoilerMakers are 0-2 vs the Falcons incl a 27-26 (-11) loss in the L/meeting ('03). The gm was tied 17-17 into the 4Q. PU led 24-20 until a BG game deciding 32 yd td pass w/2:08 left (BG took a SAF on the last pl). BG is off a 44-41 (+3) home loss to Memphis. QB Johnson hit 28-44-44-4-0 and WR Lewis had 261 (37.3) rec yds & 3 TDs but it wasn't enough. BG had a chance to tie or take the lead but their last drive was SOD just short of the 50 yd line. PU got manhandled by VT 51-24 (+5) as they were held to just 265 yds & 9 FDs. QB Appleby hit just 9-28-110-0-2. This marks the 3rd P5 conf road gm in 4 wks for BG, who snapped an 11 gm P5 conf losing streak against MD 2 wks ago.

**RUTGERS by 21 over Kansas** - First meeting & homecoming for Rutgers. KU is 3-15 SU in road openers and the Jayhawks have dropped 30 str away gms overall (last win at UTEP in '09's road opener)! They enter off a bye after losing 55-23 (+13) vs Memphis the wk prior. Rutgers is off a 28-3 (+9) loss at PSU as HC Flood was susp and not on the sideline and won't be here as well. He is all'd to cch the team during the wk however. KU has gone 1-6 SU/0-7 ATS after a reg ssn bye, with the avg SU loss by 39 ppg. RU is 13-5 SU, but is on a 2-4 ATS run prior to a reg ssn bye, but is also on an 8-4 ATS run vs non-conf foes. There's no real sked edge as Rutgers is off a physical gm with PSU and has a bye next wk, while the Jayhawks enter off a bye and have to travel to Iowa St for their B12 opener next week.

**OHIO ST by 38 over Western Michigan** - First meeting. The defending Nat'l Champion Buckeyes have surprisingly struggled on the offensive end so far TY. Neither QB Jones nor Barrett have looked like the Heisman contender that each were entering the ssn & Meyer hasn't named a str for this wk matchup. OSU had 5 TO's in their 20-13 (-34) win over NIU LW. They did have 298-190 yd, & 14-10 FD edges and did have an int ret td. WM is off a 52-20 confidence building win over FCS Murray St. HC Meyer is now 39-14-1 ATS vs non-conf foes while OSU is now 7-4 as a non-conf fav of 27+ pts. WM HC Fleck started his collegiate coaching career in '06 as a GA at Ohio St so he is very familiar with the program. The Broncos are on just a 4-10 ATS run vs the B10, but did cover their opener vs MSU and are 8-3 as an AD. Sked edge favors WM as they are fresh off a bye with a home gm against CM on deck while the Buckeyes are off a much tougher than expected gm and travel to Indiana for their B10 opener next week.

**TOLEDO by 17 over Arkansas St** - UT is 3-0 SU in this series incl a 63-44 (-3) win in last ssn's Go-Daddy.com Bowl. The tms comb for over 1000 yds (UT 541-468) incl 365 rush yds for UT, which led 35-17 at HT & 49-31 early 4Q despite allow a 94 yd IR td. The Rockets have won B2B gms vs P5 conf teams after their 30-23 (-7) OT win LW vs Iowa St. UT was up 20-10 4Q, but all'd ISU to tie the gm & send it into OT. The Rockets were outgd 481-309, outFD'd 27-16 & lost the TOP battle 38-18-21-42. RB Hunt did rush for over 100 yds for an FBS high 12th str gm. Ark St was without their st'g QB Knighten, but still set a schl rec for pts in their 70-7 win over FCS Missouri St. Backup QB Tabary hit 21-24-255 with 3 td passes. The Red Wolves are 9-4 as an AD (0-1 TY), but under HC Anderson, they're just 2-5 ATS on the road overall.

**Indiana by 7 over WAKE FOREST** - First meeting. Indiana is 3-0 SU for the 1st time s/10 after their 38-35 (-2) win over WKU. RB Howard is poised to fill the shoes of Tevin Coleman as he finished with 203 (6.6) rush yds as the Hoosiers came back from a 28-17 HT deficit. IU finished with 639-568 yd & 34-28 FD edges. WF won its 1st AG s/'13 after nailing a 47 yd fg with no time left to beat Army 17-14 (-5). True frosh QB Hinton led the comeback, scoring two 2H TDs after st'g QB Wolford inj'd his ankle (CS for this week). The Demon Deacons finished with 346-240 yd & 19-11 FD edges, but were -3 TO's. WF HC Clawson lost to Indiana while HC at BG in '13 42-10 being outgd 601-409 but were only outFD'd by 1. WF is on a 5-1 ATS run as a HD, while IU is on a 1-3 ATS run in road openers. IU is also just 2-10 SU s/'96 on the road vs current P5 non-conf opp's (just 3rd such trip in L10Y). Indiana returns home to face the defending nat'l champion Buckeyes next week while WF hosts the nat'l champion from 2Y ago, FSU.

**Georgia Tech by 17 over DUKE** - GT will be out for revenge. This series has been dominated by GT as they've won 22 of the L/25 meetings SU. The Yellow Jackets had won 10 str vs Duke by 21 ppg until LY. Duke took a 7-3 lead into the 2Q & never trailed again. Duke was up 31-12 4Q before GT went on B2B td drives. Down 6 GT's outside failed w/1:27 left. LTH ('13 road opener) the Yellow Jackets trailed 7-3 mid-1Q but would score the next 28 pts incl 3 td passes and won 38-14 (-8). Duke hasn't won B2B in this series s/'88-'89. We cashed a 4★ LPS going against the Yellow Jackets in their 30-22 (+3) loss at Notre Dame LW. GT was outgd 457-337 but did have a 21-17 FD edge as the loss also snapped their 8 gm ATS winning streak. Our UD POW won outright for a 2nd str week on these pages as we went against Duke in their 19-10 (-3) home loss to NW. GT is on a 4-1-1 ATS run in this series, but the HT is 4-1 SU/4-0-1 ATS. Despite the loss LW, Duke is still on an 18-8-1 ATS run overall and has their 4th str home gm next wk (homecoming) vs BC. After travelling for B2B wks, GT returns home vs NC next.

**MISSISSIPPI by 21 over Vanderbilt** - The visitor has dominated this series of late having won 6 of the L/7 SU incl 3 str (6-1 ATS). LY UM had a 34-9 FD & 547-167 yd edge & led 20-0 at HT & 41-0 into 4Q. VU's only scoring "drive" was after a UM fumble at UM2, went -4/4pl before a 26yd fg. LTH ('12) VU trailed 23-6 w/1:46 3Q but just 23-20 into the 4Q. After a UM 27yd fg w/2:43 left, VU went on a 79/9 pl drive scoring on a 26 yd td pass w/5:2. (UM SOD V48). UM has won B2B meetings in this series for the 1st time s/'03-04. UM is off an emotional win after going on the road to defeat Bama, 43-37 (+6). They did so despite being outgd 503-433 & outFD'd 29-16 as they were fortunate with +5 in TO's. It's their 1st time ever beating them in B2B yrs in a series that dates back to 1894 and their 1st win in Tuscaloosa s/'88. VU is off a 47-7 win over FCS Austin Peay. VU is 5-3 SU/ATS in this series, while the SU winner is also 10-0 ATS here. There have been 4 outright upsets the L7Y incl VU pulling off the upset the L/3 gms pl'd here. Ole Miss is in a Bama/Florida sandwich while VU comes off Austin Peay with only Mid Tenn and a bye on deck.

**IOWA by 24 over North Texas** - While this is the 1st ever meeting between these schls, the cch's know each other very well as NT HC McCarney led Iowa St vs Iowa every yr from '99-'06. In the L/meeting Iowa won 27-17 ('06) but McCarney holds a 5-3 edge over Ferentz. Iowa is 3-0 for the 1st time in 6Y after their 27-24 (-5) win over Pitt. PK Koehn hit a 57 yd w/td with no time left to win it. His initial attempt was short, but the Panthers called TO. Iowa had 363-282 yd & 22-15 FD edges and led 17-7 at HT. NT is off a 38-24 (+8) home loss to Rice as they were outgd 562-478, outFD'd 28-20 & lost the TOP

battle 41:50-18:10 while also being -3 TO's. The Mean Green have dropped 28 str gms when traveling to a current P5 conf opponent, their last & only wins since becoming a FBS program ('95) have come vs Texas Tech in '97 & '99. They are also on an 0-7 ATS streak on the road and as an AD. This will be a bit of a homecoming however for McCarney (grew up in Iowa City) and st'g QB McNulty (grad from Iowa City HS). Ferentz is 9-13 ATS vs non-conf teams and does have the B10 home opener on deck vs Wisconsin, but Iowa is 4-1 ATS the gm before wisky.

**ILLINOIS by 8 over Middle Tennessee** - MT has dropped both prior gms, but these schools haven't pl'd s/2000. Illinois enters off a 48-14 (+8) loss at UNC, but they were only outgd 471-399 and outFD'd by 1. RB Ferguson became the 17th pl'r in schl hist to rush for 2,000 yds in his car. MT is off a 73-14 (-19) CUSA win over Charlotte. QB Stockstill (HC's son) hit 23-27-369 with a car high 5 td passes as the Blue Raiders scored the 2nd most pts in schl history (76 in 1927)! They set the schl ttl yds mark with 695. This is the 2nd of three P5 conf tms MT will face this yr. That has happened in Stockstill's tenure 6 of his 10Y (2-15 mark when facing 3+ in same yr). ILL is 21-2 SU hosting non-B10 foes but is just 3-8 ATS vs FBS foes as a fav. MT is 3-6-1 ATS as an AD. The Blue Raiders have their homecoming gm vs Vandy on deck while Illinois has their B10 opener vs Neb on deck.

**New Mexico by 3 over WYOMING** - NM has lost 3 str trips to Laramie. LTH NM trailed 21-0 late 2Q but the gm was 24-24 w/13:16 left. After B2B Wyoming t's, New Mexico scored w/1:06 to cut the deficit in half but their onside failed. LY WY had a 29-10 FD edge, ran 94 plys vs just 39 by NM, 541-382 yd edge, was +1 TO's and held NM to 0-7 on 3D (0-2 on 4D). Thanks to a 19-yd IR td and 97-yd KR to all'd the Cowboys lost 36-30! NM is off a 34-10 (+28) loss at AZSt last Friday. The Lobos made it close as they were only down 3-0 late 2Q before talent took over. NM was outgd 449-295, but only outFD'd 19-15. Wyoming is off a 31-14 (+24) loss at Wazzu despite 409-378 yd & 22-19 FD edges. NM is 10-5 SU/ATS in the series and the home team is 6-1 SU/4-3 ATS.

**LOUISIANA TECH by 20 over Fiu** - The only prior gm was in '13. LT won 23-7 (-5). LT had a 333-197 yd edge (+11 FD) but settled for 5 fg's, all from 35 yds in. LT led 9-0 at HT & FIU's only score came on a 3Q 38-yd td drive after a LT int. LW LT led Kansas St 20-13 in the 4Q but gave up 10 str. LT then started at the LT12 and went 60/10pl kicking a FG to send it to OT. LT eventually lost in 3OT. LT outgained KSt 451-355. FIU won over a FCS 39-14. LT is 13-4 ATS and 6-3 as a HF. FIU is just 2-6 on the CUSA road but 4-1 ATS, as a dog 8-5.

**BAYLOR by 31 over Rice** - 80th meeting. Rice L/won in Waco in '91 and the LTH ('11) all'd 56 pts which is the most ever surrendered by either tm in one gm. Owls are 0-24 s/'98 vs ranked foes (L/won was in '97, 27-14 over #21 BYU). Bears have won 6 str over the Owls by 21 ppg. Baylor is off a bye and played an FCS in wk 2. BU won in '11 (-20) at home 56-31. BU is 3-0 ATS SU and ATS in the series. BU is 14-7-1 ATS as a DD Fav but have not covered their L/2. Rice defeated North Texas LW 38-24 (-7) but led 38-10 in the 3Q before NT scored 2 late TDs. Rice is 11-5-1 ATS. This gm is sandwiched between two CUSA gms, including a big HG vs WKU, that may have more of Rice's attention while Baylor has had two weeks to prepare for this gm.

**Texas A&M by 3 over Arkansas (Arlington)** - These 2 have had 3 SEC meetings and A&M is 3-0 SU with the avg win 46-24 with the two teams combining for an avg of 1,081 yds. Ark is 3-1 SU in this series in Arlington winning all 3 from '09-'11 by an avg of 38-25. That puts them 5-1 ATS in this series as LY in their return to Arlington they were +9 and lost 35-28 despite leading 28-14 in the 4Q. A&M got 86 and 59 yd td passes to tie then won it in OT. UA is off B2B NC losses but hope to wipe the slate clean in SEC play. LW UA lost as HF vs Texas Tech 35-24 (-10). UA was outgained only 486-424 but could not get stops as TT did not punt once. A&M defeated Nevada LW 44-27 (-34). A&M outgained Nev 535-359 and Allen accounted for 5 TDs. UA has depth concerns at WR with Hatcher and Hollister missing the TT game and Cornelius suffering an injury in the gm (CS). A&M is just 1-7 as a fav in conf play while UA is 5-2.

**FLORIDA by 1 over Tennessee** - LW Florida extended their streak vs Kentucky to 29 gms with a 14-9 win (-3). UF led 14-3 at HT but was shutout in the 2H. The O struggled again and one of their TDs was set up by a Hargreaves INT ret to the UK 19. UF hopes to extend another streak as they have defeated the Vols 10 str (by 14 ppg). In those 10 str, UF has outrushed UT in all 10 with Florida avg 179 ypg to 50 for UT. The last time UT outrushed UF was in 2004, which was the last time UT won. New OC DeFord has made the ground game a point of emphasis for UT. Hurd is the first UT RB to have 3 str 100 yd gms since Foster '07. UT is avg 246 rush/ypg (13th in FBS) and UF has all'd on avg 55 (7th in FBS). LTH UT led 7-0 after a 62-yd IR td but at HT trailed UF 17-7 being outgained 180-61 UT did cut the deficit to 7 in the 2H but all'd B2B long td drives. LY Harris replaced Driskell late 3Q w/the Gators down 2 scores and led UF on a pair of 4Q scoring drives. UT's L/loss was a int at UF23 w/51. The Vols are off a win over a FCS 55-10 but 2 wks ago lost a heart breaker to Oklahoma 31-24 in OT after blowing a 17 pt lead. The visitor is 6-1 ATS. UF is 8-4 ATS. Under Jones, UT is 4-1-2 as a Conf Dog.

**MINNESOTA by 10 over Ohio** - Minnesota hosts their 2nd str MAC tm TW. LW UM pulled out a squeaker vs Kent St 10-7 (-24). UM did not actually give up any offensive pts as Kent St had a FR for a TD. UM outgained Kent St 288-142 but had 3 TO's. KSt's O did not get past the UM 42 the entire gm. Ohio is 3-0 on the ssn SU and ATS, with an upset win at Marshall. LW OU won vs an FCS 35-14. UM is 8-1-1 vs Ohio incl a 42-20 win in the L/meeting ('03). The last time OU travelled to Minn in '00, they played the game in the Metrodome and OU pulled a huge upset, 23-17 (+20). Minny is a good bully and are 9-4 ATS as a HF while the Bobcats are just 2-10 as an AD.

**Wku by 21 over MIAMI, OH** - A week after being soundly beaten by Wisconsin 58-0 (+31), Miami again was heavy Dogs vs Cincy (+20). This gm was much closer with MU losing 37-33. MU led 33-30 in the 4Q, Cincy scored the gm deciding TD with 1:13 left. MU's effort was aided by an injury to UC's QB Kiel in the 3Q. MU was outgained 545-448 and UC held a 33-17 FD edge but 4 TO's and the injury to Kiel kept MU in the gm. WKU also came close to pulling an upset, losing to Indiana 38-35. WKU's Doughty was outstanding, going 35-46-484-3-3. This is the first meeting between these tms. LY Hilltoppers opened & closed their ssn vs MAC tms beating Bowling Green 59-31 (569-313 yd edge) in the ssn opener & Central Michigan 49-48 (647-607 yd edge) in their Bowl Game. UM is 1-10 SU but 5-1 ATS vs NC Opp and 5-2 as an AD. WKU is 1-5 ATS as a single digit Fav.

**Lsu by 28 over SYRACUSE** - LSU hammered Auburn LW, totalling 411 rush yds in the 45-21 win (-10). Fournette made an early bid for the Heisman as he was 19-228-3 in the win. SU lost starting. In the 2Q, SU was up 17-3 when QB Dungey went out with a head inj (CS). SU rotated their third and fourth string QBs for the rest of the game, holding on to win 30-27 in OT. SU was outgained 539-326 and had just 11 FDs as the O stalled without an experienced signal caller. SU is 3-6 ATS at home but this is LSU's first non-conference true road game since playing at West Virginia (19-6 win) in '11. LSU is 4-0 as a DD Fav. Four times LY SU lost at home by 14 pts or more incl a 17 pt loss to Duke.

## CONNECTICUT +8 over Navy

Not only has our underdog POW won in B2B issues, but they've won outright in B2B weeks! Navy is 6-1 SU vs the Huskies incl a 41-17 win the LTH ('06). Navy led 14-0 into the 2Q & maintained a DD lead the entire 2H. The Huskies all'd 464 rush yds, at the time it was the 2nd most by a UConn opp in program history. This is a much different UConn team however. The Huskies nearly pulled off a major upset LW, falling at Mizuzzo 9-6 (+21'), getting out'd just 270-233 & outFD'd 16-11. The score was misleading however, as despite the 24 pt win, the Midshipmen only had 456-405 yd & 28-25 FD edges. UConn all'd Army to rush for just 180 (5.5) 2 wks ago, which is highly respectable vs an option based offense. HC Diaco devised a fine D vs Navy in '12 while the DC at ND, but his '13 unit was overrun giving up 34 pts and hanging on at the end. Navy has a huge gm against rival AF on deck and we feel that they'll be looking ahead to that and the Huskies have proven that they are capable of being a competitive team this season. **FORECAST: CONNECTICUT BY 1**

**NOTRE DAME by 28 over Massachusetts** - Without starting QB Zaire, ND still clicked offensively vs GT LW, winning 30-22. ND actually lead 30-7 with 6:58 left in the 4Q but GT scored 2 TDs in the last 48 seconds. Kizer filled in nicely, going 21-30-242-1-1 while RB Prosis was 22-198-3. Now ND plays a gm where they will be heavily favored vs UMass. The Minutemen are 0-2 on the season but did almost upset Temple LW (+13), losing 25-23. UMass led 23-22 with just 12 secs left when Temple kicked the GW FG. ND is 2-9 as a DD Fav. UMass has not won a NC gm since joining the FBS in '12, going 0-12 SU and 5-7 ATS. ND is usually overpriced as a HF at 11-18-2 ATS. ND has a trip to Clemson on deck and may look past this game.

**Nc State by 14 over SOUTH ALABAMA** - This could be a dangerous spot for NCSt. South Alabama won LW at SDSU (+17) 34-27 in OT. USA outgained SDSU 511-305. Now South Alabama gets a P5 tm at home. These 2 met in '12 and NCST was -30' at home and only won 31-7. They did lead the game 31-0 into the 4Q but SA was only outgained 384-314 as they were -3 in TO's. LW NCSt won vs ODU 38-14 (-10). NCST has faced 3 low profile tms (wins over ODU, EKU and Troy) outscoring them 122-35 and gets a 4th vs USA. This is only USA's 2nd time hosting a P5 tm. LY they hosted Miss St losing 35-3 (+13). NCST is 6-2 vs NC Opp but does have the ACC opener vs Louisville up next.

**Georgia Southern by 13 over IDAHO** - Georgia Southern comes into this having won B2B over an FCS and WMU. Idaho also won vs an FCS LW in a close affair 41-38. ID trailed 20-10 at the half LY as they were +24' on the road at GS. Down 33-10 they would score 2 td's to trail by single digits, 33-24 and had the ball but were int'd and retd' for a td. GS would later score after ID was SOD on its own 43. GS drove 43/9 and got a td with :03 left for the 47-24 final. ID was an amazing 6-1 as a conf dog LY but has started TY 0-3 ATS. ID is giving up 47 ppg. GS is 11-0 SU and 7-4 ATS when favored.

**Marshall by 7 over KENT ST** - Kent St gave Minnesota everything they had LW before losing 10-7. Kent St only gained 142 yds and 8 FDs but got a FR TD and only all'd 288 yds themselves. Kent St's O has struggled TY only scoring 18 ppg but did play 2 B10 tms and an FCS. Marshall won vs an FCS LW 45-7. This is MU's 2nd gm vs a MAC tm TY after losing to Ohio in wk 2 21-10. Kent St is allowing 18 PPG and 199 ypg while MU avg'ing 385 yds and 32 ppg. KSt has dropped 10 straight including all 8 when the Herd was a conf opp but have not played s'04 (MU's final yr in MAC). MU is 9-5 SU and 7-7 ATS vs MAC teams since they left the conf in '04. KSU is 15-6 SU hosting non-conf foes and were 3-1 as a HD LY. MU had been 1-8-1 as an AF under Holliday but went 4-2 in that role LY.

**Florida Atlantic by 14 over CHARLOTTE** - This marks the first time that a FBS program will visit Jerry Richardson Stadium. Charlotte is 2-1 on the ssn incl their first win over an FBS tm. LW Charlotte was beaten by MT 73-14 (+21) and gave up 695 yds and had 7 TO's. FAU is 0-3 on the ssn after losing as a HF vs Buffalo 33-15. FAU actually outgained Buffalo 480-297 (27-13 FD edge) but had 5 TO's including an INT at BU 21, 60 yd FR TD, 39 yd IR TD, and a Safety. Florida Atlantic is 2-6 in CUSA road gms and its either been feast or famine as the wins are by 14 & 34 pts while the losses are by 15 ppg. FAU is 1-11 prior to a bye week. FAU is now 0-5 as a Fav.

**TCU by 14 over TEXAS TECH** - TCU won The Iron Skillet LW vs SMU 56-37 (-37) and now must go on the rd for their conf opener. TCU's lead was cut to 42-37 with 8:20 left but added two late TD's. Boykin is making his case for the Heisman going 21-30-454-5-1 plus another 11-50-1 rushing. Texas Tech was a 10 pt HD LW vs Ark and won outright 35-24. TT got 3 TDs from Mahomes and never punted. TT is on a 5-0 ATS run vs FBS tms. TT is 10-4 ATS as a HD including LTH when TCU trailed 10-0 at HT but w/6:28 left tied the gm. Down just 7 the Horned Frogs L/2 drives ended on a punt & SOD at TT28 w/40. Home tm is 7-1. LY Texas Tech only trailed 24-17 into the 2Q but after a fg w/8:35 2Q was outgained 492-100 (outscored 51-7) & 8 of their L/9 poss tld' 25/22pl. The Red Raiders are 6-21 vs ranked foes. TCU is 6-3 as a DD Fav but have dropped their last 2.

**UL LAFAYETTE by 7 over Akron** - These 2 have 1 meeting and that was '13. ULL was -6 and went into Akron and won but only 35-30. Cajuns trailed 24-21 early Q but went on a 61/7 pl & a 54/5pl drive for td's the last with 6:19 as Zips scored with just :29 left (2pt ng), but ULL rec onside.

Zips are 2-2 vs current Sun Belt conf teams but their last trip vs an SBC tm was in '12 at FIU (now in CUSA), a 41-38 loss in OT. UA is off a 52-9 win vs an FCS. UA is 0-3 ATS to start this ssn while ULL is 1-1. In gm 1, ULL gave Kentucky a scare, losing 40-33 (+17). ULL is 5-2-1 off a SU win. This may come down to if Akron can stop ULL's run as ULL avg's 303 ypg while Akron is giving up just 100 rush ypg and held Oklahoma's Perine to 11-33 in wk 1. Akron starts Conf play next wk vs Ohio U.

**Colorado State by 14 over UTSA** - CSU is off a tough loss to rival Colorado 27-24 in OT. CSU outplayed CO for much of the game, outgaining the Buffs 500-345 (27-18 FD Edge). CSU had 2 costly TO's (one INT TD), missed 2 FGs in regulation, SOD on CO 24 on and had a FG blk'd in OT. Now CSU must bounce back as an AF vs UTSA. The Roadrunners were beaten by OKSt 69-14 and had 7 TO's that didn't help their cause. This will be UTSA's 4th str gm playing as the dog. UTSA is 2-5 ATS in NC play. UTSA is also 2-5 ATS as an AD. This is their first meeting. Both tms open their conf play next wk. When a new HC with no college HC exp plays his first tee AG, the favorite is 18-0 SU. That's good news for the Rams here.

**SOUTH CAROLINA by 14 over Ucf** - Playing w/o starting QB Mitch, SC was overwhelmed by Georgia 52-20 LW. SC all'd UGA QB Lambert to set NCAA Comp % Rec by going 24-25-330-3. UGA held a 576-258 yd and 32-16 fd edge as Orth struggled 6-17-66-0-1 and lost Wilds to injury (CS). We are shocked to see UCF at 0-3 (0-3 ATS) this ssn as they lost 16-15 to FCS Furman! While UCF is 0-4 SU vs S Carolina, these teams met in '13 and UCF outplayed them in the 1H with a 10-0 lead. SC would score 4 td's in their first 5 poss of the 2H and prevailed on th road, 28-25 (-7). SC is 2-6 ATS as a HF and 1-4 when a single digit HF. UCF 1-6 SU vs NC Opp.

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**OREGON by 13 over Utah** - Utah was not looking ahead to this gm LW as they beat Fresno 45-24. Utah had actually held FSU to 3 pts to start the 4Q and led 38-10 in the 4Q but gave up some late TD's before scoring another of their own. UO won easily LW vs Georgia St 61-28 without Adams who was out with a broken finger (CS). Utah is now 5-1 SU (3-3 ATS) in this series but the home team is 5-1 SU (3-3 ATS). While LY's final score shows Utah losing 51-27 (+8) on the road it could have been a much different game as Utah WR Clay dropped the ball heading into the EZ which would have made it 14-0 and UO picked it up and retd' it for a td to tie it, a huge turnaround. LTH Utah trailed 44-14 mid-4Q (22% of their tll yds came on their L/poss). UO is 3-0 as a single digit HF vs Conf foe while Utah is 3-1 as a single digit Dog.

**Appalachian State by 3 over OLD DOMINION** - First mtg. App St had a bye wk to prepare for this gm after being beaten by Clemson 41-10. LW ODU lost to NC St 38-14 (+17). ODU RB Lawry was held to 11-15 after avg 218 ypg. App St is 3-4 on the road but won 3 in a row by 21 ppg (+215 ypg) beating 2 bowl squads prior to the loss to Clemson. ODU's HC Wilder was on Maine's staff from '90-'06 and in '02 beat App St 14-13 in an IAA 1st Rnd Playoff game where Wilder was the OC. ODU is 0-6 as a HF and App St is 4-3-1 ATS as an AD. ODU is 0-3 ATS to start this ssn.

**BOSTON COLLEGE by 7 over Northern Illinois** - We won our Friday night marquee going against BC LW in their 14-0 (+7) home loss to FSU. It was a defensive battle as both teams combined for just 412 yds. BC limited FSU RB Cook, who entered #2 in the FBS in rush yds, to just 54 (3.6). The Eagles lost st'g QB Wade to a broken ankle and is OFY. Jeff Smith & Troy Flutie (Doug's nephew) both took QB snaps. NIU played the Natl Champs down to the wire LW at OSU losing 20-13 +34. NIU was tied at HF and down 3 in the 3Q when they gave up a 41 yd IR TD. NIU did cut the deficit to 7 and had multiple chances to tie but the OSU D was too much. NIU was outgained 298-190 but forced 5 TO's to stay in the gm. Huskies are 1-8 vs current ACC tms but won the most recent reg ssn game 42-41 over Wake Forest in '02. Adzazio is 5-2 ATS as a HF and 9-3 ATS at home overall. LY off a loss to FSU they bounced back and beat Syr 28-7 (-11).

**Oklahoma St by 2 over TEXAS** - It pays to be the visitor in this series. Believe it or not, the visitor has been favored six str years and is 6-0 (wins by 18 ppg) SU and ATS. LTH Okla St was +3 and won outright 38-13. LY Texas led 19-0 at HT all'ing just 51 yds and forcing four 3&outs. TX appeared beaten LW vs Cal, down 45-24 to start the 4Q. TX scored TD's with 13:24, 3:00, and 1:11. However the XP was blocked after the last TD and TX lost 45-44. After switching to Heard, the TX offense appears to have hit their stride. Heard's 527 yds of total O are most in school history. OKSt is off an easy 69-14 win over UTSA. OKSt forced 7 TO's in the game and held a 529-346 yd edge. Cowboys are 5-24 but have won 3 of the L/5 vs the Longhorns.

**NORTHWESTERN by 24 over Ball St** - First meeting. NW is 3-0 and won for the 2nd time as a dog LW vs Duke as we cashed in for the 2nd wk in a row on the Underdog POW (2 outright wins in a row!). NW was outgained 327-271 but forced 3 TO's and took a 98 yd KR for a TD. NW was last 3-0 in '13 but lost their next seven straight so cch's will be determined to not let that happen again. Northwestern is 19-2 the L8Y hosting non-conf incl 2-0 TY. The Wildcats had won 10 str vs current MAC tms until LY (17-10-1 all-time). BSU is 3-24-1 all-time vs the Big Ten but the 3 wins have all come within the L7Y (all against instate Indiana). Fitzgerald is 11-22 as a HF. NW is 3-0 as a DD HF. NW has their B10 opener vs Minn on deck.

**Ucla by 10 over ARIZONA** - Two ranked tms face off in this P12 opener. The HT is 8-3 SU in this series, 10-2 ATS. LY the Wildcats led 7-3 at HT despite being outgained 224-103. UA all'd the go ahead score w/6:54 3Q, getting shutout in the 2H but missed a 39-yd fg, had a 26-yd'r blk'd & was int'd at UCLA42. LTH UCLA led 24-10 late 3Q and won 31-26 (+2). UCLA had to come from behind LW to defeat BYU 24-23 despite 3 costly FH INT's. UCLA leaned on their running game (Perkins 26-219-1 in the 2nd half. UCLA trailed by 10 in the 4Q and scored TDs with 12:16 and 3:21 (gm deciding TD). UA did win LW vs an FCS 77-13, breaking a 94 year old school record for most pts in a gm. UA has outscored their competition 163-65 TY but this is the first team from a P5 conf that UA will play. UCLA is 3-0 ATS against UA. The Bruins are just 13-23 in P12 AG's but have won 6 str (started LTH).

**California by 4 over WASHINGTON** - This is the P12 opener. Cal barely survived a furious comeback LW at Texas. Cal led 45-24 going into the 4Q but Texas came all the way back, scoring what appeared to be the GT TD with 1:11 left. However, Texas had their PAT blocked and Cal held on 45-44 (-6). Cal was outgained 650-548, although TX did get 236 yds during their 4Q comeback. UW played well LW vs Utah St, winning 31-17 (-7) with an 442-254 yd edge. The HT is 6-3 SU in this series but 4-6 ATS. LY UW led 28-0 at HT w/a 277-195 yd edge. For the gm Cal had more yds but UW forced 5 fml's recovering 3 that resulted in 17 pts in just 16 tll yds incl a 100-yd FR td w/gm 0-0. UW has now won 6 in a row SU in this series and has 5 outright upsets the last 8 years. UW has started TY 3-0 ATS.

**SAN JOSE ST by 6 over Fresno St** - This is the conf opener for these teams. SJSt has lost 17 of the L/20 games but LY's loss snapped a 2-gm series winning streak (1st s'86 & '87). After leading 14-7 late 2Q SJSt all'd 21 pts in a 2:02 span after an int, 21-yd PR and a blk'd punt. LTH's gm had 9 lead changes. FSU trailed 42-41 at HT (most pts at HT between 2 tms in MW history) but all'd 20 of the first 23 2H pts before a td w/2:03 left. LW FSU lost to Utah 45-24. FSU trailed 24-3 to start the 4Q. FSU did score 21 pts in the 4Q but never got closer than 14. SJSt played Oregon St and led 21-14 at HT but became unraveled in the 3Q giving up 21 pts to lose 35-21. SJSt was outgained 438-253 and 2 of their scores came off converted TO's. SJSt actually used 3 QBs in that gm as starter Porter left with an ankle injury, then Joe Gray was replaced due to ineffectiveness. FSU is 8-4 in MW AG's and 3-0 ATS as an AD.
