4★ OKLAHOMA over West Virginia - This is the B12 opener for both teams. OU has won all 3 meetings SU as B12 rivals but is 1-2 ATS. The Sooners enter fresh off a bye and HC Stoops is 16-16 ATS in that role and has been beaten their L/2 off a bye at home despite being DD Favs in both! Prior to the bye, OU put up 773 yds of offense in a 52-38 (-30') win vs Tulsa. QB Mayfield set the schl rec with 572 tll yds and accounted for 6 tds. The OU D struggled however, giving up 603 tll yds incl 427 thru the air. WV is off a 45-6 (-16') route over MD in a gm that was important for recruiting, cashing us an easy 3★ on these pages LW. RB Smallwood rushed for a car high 147 yds and QB Howard threw 4 td passes along with his 1st int of the year but he has an outstanding 17-1 ratio in his career! OU is 5-11 ATS as a HF vs B12 foes, while WV is 12-8 as a dog. LY OU was our B12 POW on the Compline #9 and won 45-33 (-7). OU has their Red River Rivalry with Texas on deck while WV has homecoming vs OKSt on deck. Oklahoma always seems to do well when the pressure is off and while many of the technical edges favor WV, look for Oklahoma to get a statement win and make a name for themselves as serious players in the B12 Conference.

FORECAST: OKLAHOMA BY 17

3★ Notre Dame (+) over CLEMSON - Clemson enters fresh off a bye after their win the previous Thurs night at Louisville in their conf opener. RB Gallman rushed for 139 yds as the Tigers finished with 202 rush yds. It was their 32nd str win over an unranked AP foe, the 2nd longest streak in the nation behind Bama (58). Clemson's stout D, has all'd just 261 ypg and 12 ppg. This will be a tough test for QB Kizer as his first road start will be in Death Valley. LW ND took a while to get going before handling UMass 62-27 (-29'). RB Prosis became the first to run for 100 in 3/str s/05. ND could have a tough test against the CU run D. CU has won 17 str vs NC Opp. ND is just 2-10 in true AG's vs ranked tms, but 9-4-1 ATS overall vs ranked tms. Notre Dame won going away as an underdog 2 wks ago and will look to do so again this week against a Clemson team that could be overconfident here

FORECAST: NOTRE DAME BY 3

3★ UCLA over Arizona State - A big thank you to all of our Power Sweep subscribers as we were happy to provide you with a free Sept 5★ GOM winner going against Ariz St as they lost to USC 42-14 (+5'). The gm was essentially over at HT as the Sun Devils were down 35-0! Not only did we cash that play, but we also easily cashed a 3★ LPS on UCLA in their 56-30 (-2) win at Arizona. True frosh QB Rosen threw for 284 yds with 3 tll td's in his 1st ever P12 road gm as the Bruins had a 42-14 lead at HT and never looked back. Prior to LY's meeting, the L/3 meetings between these schools had been decided by a tll of just 8 pts. In LY's Thurs night meeting, both tms had backup QB's and the Bruins won 62-27 despite being just a 4 pt fav! The Visitor in this series is 3-0 SU/ATS. UCLA is 23-14 as a HF while AZSt is 11-16-2 as an AD. UCLA has been getting things done using a rush attack that is avg 234 (5.6) rush ypg but the Sun Devils have a respectable rush D that only all'd 76 (2.4) vs USC LW. That being said, we've got a good feel for both of these teams and UCLA is rising while Arizona St is falling.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ IOWA ST over Kansas - This is the 95th all-time meeting between these B12 Rivals. Iowa St was on a bye LW. Rhodes is 2-5-10 ATS off a bye. ISU lost to Toledo in OT 30-23 (+7') prior to their bye. ISU outgained Toledo 481-309 and held a 27-16 FD edge but 113 yds in penalties did not help the Cyclone cause. ISU also had a TO on the UT 15 and missed a 32 yd GW FG. Kansas has now lost 30 str road gms after their 27-14 (+14') loss at Rutgers LW. The Jayhawks were outg'd 513-342 & outFD'd 31-18. ISU had won 4 in a row in this series but were upset 34-14 (-3) and will be in revenge mode here. The home team is 11-6-1 ATS and KU is 15-26-1 as an AD. After struggling to run the ball to start the ssn, the Cyclones had 207 (4.2) LW and that could be the spark they needed as the Jayhawks are all'g 297 (5.4) vs FBS foes this ssn and rank near the bottom of our rush D rankings.

FORECAST: IOWA ST BY 21

2★ AKRON (+) over Ohio - The Bobcats have dominated this series of late, winning 7 in a row. LY's gm had 6 lead changes & 3 ties as OU won 23-20 (+3). Akron enters off a respectable 35-14 road win over ULL. Leading just 14-7 at HT, the Zips pulled away in the 2H as they forced 4 TO's and won 35-14 (+8). OU nearly pulled off a major upset LW before falling 27-24 (+10) at Minn. The Bobcats were tied at 14 at HT and led late 4Q before all'g the GW td w/30 left. OU was outg'd 468-345 & outFD'd 24-18. After losing 5 str in Akron ('99-'07), OU has won all 3 in InfoCision Stadium (opened '09). The Bobcats are on a 6-1 ATS run in this series and are 4-0 ATS this year. The Zips are on a 2-9 overall ATS run and are just 6-16 as a HD. Despite those technical edges favoring the Bobcats, we feel Akron is an underrated team this year and will end the losing streak against their MAC rival.

2★ ULM (+) over Georgia Southern - LY ULM (+15) held GS to a ssn low 3 pts at half and 22 pts total was 30 pts below their tm avg. GS has outgained their L3 opp, winning all 3 by an avg 45-17. The GS ground game ran all over Idaho LW with 441 yds (8.5 ypc) in the 44-20 win (-16). GS outgained ID 568-395 with a 23-20 FD edge. ULM will be glad to start SBC play after being soundly beaten at Bama 34-0 (+38) which cashed us a 4★ LPS winner as well as a 2★ play on these pages! ULM had just 92 yds of O and 9 Rush yds. This was the second SEC tm to beat up on the Warhawks TY (Georgia beat ULM 51-14 in w1). Now that SBC play is underway, look for ULM to play up to their potential and will feel disrespected as a home underdog against a 2nd yr FBS program.

Miami, FI at CINCINNATI - Miami is fresh off a bye for this Thursday night affair. UM is 10-0 SU/7-3 ATS off a reg ssn bye. The week prior, the Canes (-3) led Neb 33-10 with 8:36 left when the wheels fell off. Neb came back and forced OT w/33 left. UM got an int in the OT & then kicked the GW FG to win 36-33, infuriating their backers in the process. The Canes had 2 TD's called back in the 2H and 2 key defenders ejected. UM is on a 7-3 run as an AF and are 20-3 ATS their L/22 SU road win. The Canes have a rivalry gm on deck vs FSU. Cincy is off a 53-46 (+7') loss at Memphis last Thurs. QB Kiel was a ? coming in after a conc the week prior, but he st'd and was laid out in the 1Q, getting taken to the hospital on a stretcher. Rfr QB Moore set a UC record with 557 pass yds & the Bearcats set a schl rec w/752 tll yds in the loss. UC is on just a 1-5 ATS run overall, but are 7-1 as a HD. Memphis at USF - USF is off a bye here. That might not be good news for the Bulls who are 2-10 ATS off a reg ssn bye. Temple at CHARLOTTE - First meeting. Temple comes in fresh off a bye. In their last gm the wk prior, TU needed a Def 2 pt conv and hit a GW fg w/02 left to squeak out a 25-23 (-13) win at Umass. QB Walker hit 28-48-391-1-2 and Charlotte has struggled defending the pass as they are all'g 274 ypg, 65% vs FBS foes and rank near the bottom of our pass eff D rankings. The 49ers are off a 17-7 (+10) home loss to FAU. They deserved better as they only all'd 225 tll yds but had SEVEN TO's! TU is on a 6-2 ATS run and are 9-5 ATS on the road. While TU is just 3-4 SU in non-conf AG's, their avg win is by 31 ppg.

Connecticut at BYU - Just one prior meeting, LY's ssn opener won by BYU 35-10 (-14'). The Cougars get a much needed return home after B2B road gms at P5 Conf tms. The travel finally caught up with BYU after playing their 4th gm in 4 diff time zones. They were hammered at Michigan LW 31-0 (+5'). The Cougars had just 105 tll yds and 8 FD's. UConn couldn't make it three in a row underdog POW winners as they fell 28-18 (+8') at home to Navy LW. BYU is on a 5-2 ATS run, but is 1-5 as a HF, while UConn is just 4-12 as an AD. Could this be our Friday night Marquee? Find out after noon EST on gameday.

OCT 3 (SAT)

GEORGIA TECH by 14 over North Carolina - GT is 14-3 and the home tm is on a 9-3 run. There were 7 lead changes LY incl 2 in the final 4 min as NC won 48-43 (pick'em). That loss snapped a 5 gm series winning streak for the Yellow Jackets, so they will be in revenge mode here. GT's option based rush attack has been shut down since stepping up in competition the LW as they are avg under 200 rush ypg (3.7) their L/2 gms. They only all'd 11 FD at Duke LW but still got upset 34-20 (-8'). NC comes in essentially off a bye after dismantling FCS Delaware 41-14. In their 2 gms vs FBS foes this season, the Tar Heels are all'g 241 (5.2) rush ypg and their rush D could be just what the Yellow Jackets need to get some confidence back. GT is on an 8-2 ATS run vs FBS foes and is 18-8-1 vs the ACC while NC HC Fedora is on a 3-7 run as an AD.

PENN ST by 24 over Army - Army's L/win at State College was in 1963 & the last meeting between these schools was in 1979, well before any of the current players were born. The Black Knights have dropped 6 str vs P5 Conf schls on the road by an avg of 19 ppg. In '11 a Franklin led Vandy squad beat Army 44-21 with a 530-288 yd edge, but Army did rush for 270 (5.3). PSU is off a 37-21 (-15) win vs SDSt. They had commanding 400-242 yd and 19-13 FD edges. QB Hackenberg moved into 2nd place on the schools all-time passing list and is under 1,000 yds away from becoming the car leader. They were however, down to their 3rd string 5'6" rFr RB after injuries to their top 2. Army picked up their 1st win of the ssn LW, beating EM 58-36 (+2). They had 654-473 yd, 29-24 FD & 41-21-18:39 TOP edges. EM came in with our worst ranked rush D and Army had 556 rush yds! The yds won't come as easy this week as the Nittany Lions have a top 10 rush D in our rankings. Army is just 3-18 ATS on the road, while PSU HC Franklin is 8-1 as a DD non-conf HF.

Bowling Green by 10 BUFFALO - This is the MAC opener for both schools. BG has won their L/5 trips to Buffalo by an avg of 13 ppg. LY's gm saw 8 lead changes as the Falcons squeaked out a 36-35 (-3) win. BG is coming off their 2nd win over a B10 school TY after going on the road and beating Purdue 35-28, as they scored the GW td w/09 left. The Falcons had 539-426 yd & 39-25 FD edges. QB Johnson hit 43-59-402-1-1. BU is off a 24-21 (pick'em) home loss to Nevada despite 487-379 & 23-15 FD edges as they were -3 in TO's. The Bulls do have a respectable pass D as they rank in the upper half of our pass eff D rankings, so Johnson could find the passing lanes a bit tighter this week. Tech edges favor BU as the visitor is 8-0 ATS in this series with 4 outright upsets the L/6 meetings. BG is just 2-10 ATS in MAC openers while the Bulls are 4-1 in that role.

Toledo by 7 over BALL ST - Rockets are just 4-7 in Muncie s/93. Toledo was -14 LY and the gm had a 2 hr 40 min weather delay. The Rockets won 34-23. UT enters undefeated after their 37-7 (-7') home win over Ark St. The only TD they all'd was a 92 yd KOR. The Rockets had 477-209 yd & 29-11 FD edges and forced 5 TO's. RB Hunt, who entered leading the FBS with 12 str 100 yd rush gms didn't play after inj his hamstring the wk prior and his status for this game is ? (CS). BS nearly pulled the upset before falling 24-19 (+20) at NW LW. The Cardinals were outg'd 546-359 & outFD'd 23-17, but were +2 in TO's. UT is on a 5-1-1 ATS run, but are just 6-12 as an AF, while BS is on a 1-6 ATS run at home, but HC Lembo is 16-10 as a dog. The Visitor in this series is on a 6-1 ATS run.

APPALACHIAN ST by 21 over Wyoming - This will be just the 2nd all time meeting between these schools with the 1st coming in 2004, a 53-7 Wyoming win at home. HC Satterfield was the QB cch in that loss. Times have changed since then as App St is now a full fledged FBS program and is coming off a 49-0 (-8') demolition over ODU LW as QB Lamb threw a car high 4 td passes on only 15 pass atts! The Mountaineers led 35-0 at HT and had 501-175 yd & 24-8 FD edges in the gm! Wyoming enters still looking for its first win of the ssn after their 38-28 (+3) home loss to NM. They were down 28-7 late 1H, but did have a 26-15 FD edge and were +2 in TO's. This is just the 3rd trip to an East coast state for the Pokes, but they are 21-9 as an AD.

KENT ST by 14 over Miami, Oh - This is the MAC opener for both schools. The home team has won 4 of the L/6 meetings in this series SU incl B2B. LY KS trailed 7-3 at HT and lost 10-3 (+6'). Miami enters off a 56-14 (+20') loss at WKU as they were outg'd 569-291, outFD'd 27-15 & were -4 in TO's. They all'd QB Doughty to throw for 6 td's (5 in the 1H) and 457 yds. KS is off an emotional & unfortunate 36-29 (+7) 2OT home loss vs Marshall. The Golden Flashes had a 19-7 lead 3Q but couldn't hold on and needed a 93 yd fg w/4:55 left to play 4Q to tie the gm. Kent had 436-277 yd & 20-16 FD edges but all'd a 33 yd KOR td. The away team in this series is on a 7-3 ATS run. The Flashes are avg 263 (4.4) rush ypg at home while the RedHawks are all'g 183 (4.2) rush ypg and rank near the bottom of our rush D rankings.

MICHIGAN ST by 23 Purdue - PU has not surprisingly dropped 6 str in this series but 2 of the L/4 were surprisingly by just 3 and 4 pts. PU has covered the L/3 by 12 ppg. LY with MSU leading 38-31 (-21) the Spartans got a 15 yd IR td for a 14 pt non-covering win. Sparty enters off a 30-10 (-26') home win vs in-state rival CMU. They lost st'g OT Conklin to a knee inj and it's not known how severe that inj is at presstime. MSU was actually outg'd 340-324 and they needed two 4Q td's to finally pull away. Purdue enters winless vs FBS foes this season and is coming off a 35-28 (+3) home loss to Bowling Green. The Boilermakers were outg'd 539-426 & outFD'd 39-25 as they all'd over 400 pass yds. MSU is just 8-15 as a HF, but are 8-4 ATS in their B10 opener and PU is on an 0-3 ATS run in their B10 opener.

UMASS by 6 over FIU - This is the first meeting between these schools. FIU is off a 27-17 (+14) loss at LT as they were outg'd 472-308 & outFD'd 29-18. They are avg just 100 (3.4) rush ypg and all'g 166 (4.0) rush ypg on the road this season. Umass is still searching for their 1st win of the ssn after their 62-27 (+29) loss at Notre Dame as they were outg'd 681-450 and outFD'd 30-22. The Minute-men are having success on offense as they are avg 428 ypg despite playing two P5 Conf teams, but their defense has struggled all'g 566 ypg incl 305 (6.2) rush ypg! This is a CUSA sandwich gm for FIU, who is also traveling for the 4th time in a 5 wk stretch, which will likely take its toll. Ron Turner is just 3-10 SU on the road at FIU and UMass is on a 3-1 run as a HF.

NORTHWESTERN by 8 over Minnesota - This is the B10 opener for both teams. Minnesota continues to play with fire as they came from behind to squeak out another win last week vs Ohio 27-24 (-10). Down 24-20 late 4Q, the Gophers got a GW 3 yd td run w/30 left to play. NW had 7 players leave the gm due to inj LW in their 24-19 (-19) home win over Ball St. The Wildcats did have 546-359 yd & 23-17 FD edges. LY NW (+3) never led despite +119 yds+14 FD. After tying the gm 17-17 w/7:32 left Minn ret the ensuing KO 100 yds for a td & won 24-17. Minn is on a 12-5 ATS run in this series and HC Kill is on a 9-2 ATS run vs the B10. NW counters with a 6-2 overall ATS run, but is just 2-9 as a HF. The Gophers have struggled to get their ground gm going this ssn, but found some success LW vs Ohio. They may struggle again this week however, as NW has an underrated rush D and held Stanford to just 85 (3.1) earlier this ssn. On the flip side, the Wildcats are avg 265 (4.5) rush ypg and Minn has been just avg defending the run, all g 151 (3.9), but if you take out the Kent St gm, the Gophers avg balloons up to 175 (4.3) rush ypg.

NC STATE by 6 over Louisville - After starting the ssn 0-3 for the 1st time s/'84, Louisville got a much needed win over FCS Samford LW. It's not as if the Cardinals were being outplayed in their F/3 losses, as they came by a comb'd 13 points. Losing players on the D side to the NFL has taken its toll on the Cardinals. The most rush yds Louisville all'd during the reg ssn LY was 173, as they all'd just 93 (2.9) in ACC play. In their L/4 gms vs FBS foes (includes LY's bowl gm) they've all'd 200+ rush yds 3X, avg 227.5 (4.8). NCST is off a 63-13 (-17) throttling of South Alabama as they rushed for 330 yds! Not good news for Cardinals backers there, but the SOS highly favors the Cards as they've played our 27th toughest sked & NCST has ply'd just our #127 ranked sked! LY was the first meeting as ACC rivals and LVille won 30-18 (-18). UL is on a 19-7 ATS run on the road, while the Wolfpack are on a 7-0 ATS run overall, but just 6-10-1 ATS vs ACC foes. Sked edge highly favors the Cards as they are essentially off a bye with a bye on deck while NCST is travelling on a short week to Blacksburg.

WISCONSIN by 10 over Iowa - The Heartland Trophy will be at stake in this B10 rivalry game. This is the conf opener for both schools. Despite being B10 rivals the last time Wisconsin has hosted Iowa was 2009. LY was tied 3-3 into the 2Q and twice in the 4Q Iowa cut the deficit to 2 but down 26-24 elected to kick deep & UW ran out the final 5:01 w/2 big FD's (L/on a 3rd&8 from W38). Iowa is off a 62-16 (-25) dismantling of NTx as RB Canzeri rushed for 115 yds and tied a schl rec with 4 td's. The Hawkeyes D scored another TD & they have scored as many as they've all'd this ssn! We upgraded our 2★ on these pages LW to a 3★ LPS on Saturday backing the Badgers in their 28-0 (-24) win over Hawaii as they held their 3rd str non-conf foe without a td. The visitor is 6-2 SU/ATS in this series. UW is 21-13 as a HF vs B10 foes while Iowa is 4-8 as an AD. Much will be learned about both of these teams following this meeting.

VIRGINIA TECH by 7 over Pittsburgh - This is the ACC opener for both schools. Pitt comes in fresh off a bye after having played B2B AGs. This will be Pitt's first time in that role under HC Narduzzi. The week prior the Panthers lost an emotional gm at Iowa 27-24 (+5). After tying the gm w/5:52 left, Pitt all'd Iowa to kick the GW 57 yd fg w/no time left. VT returns home after B2B road trips and enters off a stunning 35-28 (-9) loss at EC in a downpour. It was the most pts the Hokies have ever all'd against the Pirates in a series that spans 20 gms. VT's offense has been consistent despite an inexp'd QB as they are avg 453 ypg incl 206 (4.5) on the ground, but their D is all g 206 (5.5) rush ypg. The Panthers however, with the loss of their star RB are avg just 91 (2.5) rush ypg and just 295 tt ypg vs FBS foes. The D has been a bright spot however as they are all g just 293 ypg incl just 94 (3.4) rush and just 52.9% compl. Pitt is just 1-4 as an AD vs ACC foes, but is on a 7-1 ATS run in this series with 4 outright upsets the L/6 meetings! However, the home team in this series has won 4 str both SU/ATS. The key matchup in this gm will be WR Boyd vs CB Fuller, both preseason 1st tm AA's!

TEXAS A&M by 6 over Mississippi St - A&M is 2-1 SU in this series as SEC rivals but 1-2 ATS. LY #6 A&M fell to #12 MSU 48-31 (+2) despite only being outgained 559-526 and will be in revenge mode this year. The undefeated Aggies are off a come from behind 28-21 (-7) OT win at Arkansas. They tied it up w/2:50 to go 4Q and then stunned the Hogs in OT. QB Allen has B2B 300 yd passing gms and while MSt appears to have a solid pass D, that could be smoke and mirrors as they actually rank near the bottom of our pass eff D rankings and are all g 67% completions. The Bulldogs are off a 17-9 (+2) win at Auburn as they had four defensive stops in the red zone. QB Prescott had his way with Auburn in his career as he finished with 729 pass, 268 rush & 7 tt td's vs the Tigers in 3 gms. A&M is just 1-7 as a HF vs SEC foes while MSt is 9-2 as an SEC dog incl 5-1 as an SEC AD. Sked edge favors the Aggies however, as they have a bye on deck while the Bulldogs are travelling in B2B wks but do have a matchup with lowly Troy at home on deck.

Ucf by 4 over TULANE - This is the AAC opener for both teams. Both teams enter with just 1 combined win on the season and that lone win was in TU's last gm vs FCS Maine. TU enters fresh off a bye for this week. UCF looked like they had a chance at pulling the upset after leading 14-5 late 2Q at SC, but they were promptly outscored 26-0 from that point on and lost 31-14 (+14). The Knights were out'd 400-230 & outFD'd 20-15 and enter this gm ranking near the bottom of our pass eff D rankings. In LY's meeting UCF had 4 TO's but still won 20-13 (-19). That was the lone ATS loss in this series for the Knights as they are on a 5-1 SU/ATS run. The Green Wave are 2-10 ATS as a dog incl 0-5 as a HD. The Green Wave were outscored in their 1st 2 gms 102-17 and outgained by 682 yds, although 323 of that came from trying to defend GT's option. TU has struggled to run the ball vs their 2 FBS opp, avg 48 (1.7) ypg.

OKLAHOMA ST by 10 over Kansas St - KSt is fresh off a bye and is 5-0 ATS after a bye. The week prior the Wildcats beat LT in OT 39-33 (-10), but were out'd 451-355 & outFD'd 23-17. KSt had trouble protecting the QB as LT had 5 sks (LT only had 3 sks in 2 prior gms). OKSt enters this game undefeated after receiving a gift in LW's 30-27 (-3) win at Texas. Despite having 395-290 yd & 27-11 FD edges the gm was tied, but the Pokes took advantage of UT's punter mishandling a perfect snap and were able to kick a GW 40 yd fg w/06 remaining. This came after a 41 yd fg tied the gm with just 1:33 to play as UT had taken the lead following a 41 yd int ret late 3Q. In LY's meeting between these two schools, KSt (-12) was a 4★ LPS winner as they rolled to a 48-14 win, finishing with a 421-260 yd edge. KSt has covered their last 3 in Stillwater, all as an underdog but lost all 3 SU. Since Snyder took over again in '09, KSt is 37-14-1 ATS in B12 play and 21-8 as a Dog. The Pokes however, are 29-15-1 as a HF.

Houston by 6 over TULSA - This is the AAC opener for both schools. Tulsa enters this gm fresh off a bye, and they are on a 9-5 ATS run in that role. The week prior they lost a shootout at Oklahoma 52-38 (+30) as they were out'd 773-603 & outFD'd 39-31. The Golden Hurricane have put up over 600 yds of offense in each of their 3 gms this ssn. OG Evans has been outstanding (71-114-1172-8-2). Houston enters this game undefeated following LW's 59-14 (-16) dismantling of TXSt as QB Ward had 6 td's! The Cougars had 689-401 yd & 29-21 FD edges as HC Herman (former Buckeye OC) has UH's offense scorching. LY UH (-20) won this matchup 38-28. While Tulsa's offense has also been red hot, UH was even able to gain 462 yds vs a respectable LVille D incl 226 (4.0) on the ground. Tulsa's D is near the bottom of our rankings in both rush & pass eff and that could be the deciding factor in this gm. TU is 1-5 as a HD and are on just an 8-19 ATS run overall while UH is on a 10-5-1 ATS run vs AAC foes.

STANFORD by 17 over Arizona - Surprisingly these P12 rivals haven't met s/2012. Stanford comes in after winning B2B P12 road gms, most recently a 42-24 (-15) win over OSU as we easily cashed our Friday Night Marquee on the OVER. QB Hogan came in as a ? after inj his ankle vs USC, but he was able to play but the Cardinal relied on their run gm, rushing for 325 (6.8) their most s/'11 (vs UW). RB McCaffrey had a car high 206 (6.9) and Barry Sanders (son of the legend) had 97 on just 7 carries with 2 td's incl a highlight reel 65 yd'r. Hogan wasn't relied on heavily as he att'd just 14 passes. We easily cashed a 3★ LPS going against Ariz in their 56-30 (+2) home loss to UCLA. The Wildcats all'd the Bruins to rush for 213 (4.5) in the loss, which needs to get corrected if they want to have a chance this week. SU is 5-2 as a HF and is 8-2 SU/ATS in this series and has a bye on deck. Arizona is just 8-12 as an AD.

Tcu by 17 over TEXAS - TCU last won 2 str in this series in 1958-'59. LY's 38-pt MOV was the larg-est s/'78 (TCU 48-10 -6). TCU escaped Lubbock LW w/a 55-52 win (-5) scoring a td w/29 left off a tipped ball. Texas on the other hand was unlucky dropping a heartbreaking gm vs OSU 30-27 (+3). UT all'd a GW fg w/10 after a mishandled snap by the punter. TCU is 2-1 SU/ATS in B12 gms vs UT but prior dropped 28 of 29. Both come in with explosive QB's (TCU Boykin avg 421 ypg) but after a 527 tt yd effort 2W ago, UT Heard was held to 167 LW (119 pass). UT does have the RRR on deck & this is TCU's HC. TCU is 7-1 as a HF & under HC Strong UT is 0-2 as a AD incl a 38-3 (+9) loss TY in South Bend albeit before the QB/playcalling changes. Tough to figure out the mindset of UT after B2B tough losses (missed XP vs Cal) and TCU still will be w/o as much as 6 defensive starters here (all'd 508 & 607 yds each of the L2W).

NAVY by 3 over Air Force - AF is 1-4 in Annapolis (win in '11). AF has now won 3 of the last 5 in this series (2-3 ATS). The one common theme in the series is upset as there have been 8 outright upsets in the L12Y and the dog is 10-1-1 ATS. The previous 18 winners have gone on to win the Commander-in-Chief's Trophy. AF gets a bye to prepare for the rivalry gm but is only 3-4 SU and 1-6 ATS off a bye. Navy is 3-0 for the 1st time s/'06 & QB Reynolds (142 rush yds, 5.1) after 3 td's LW is tied for #2 all-time in NCAA history (UW RB Ball #1 w/77) w/73 rush td's. Both are 3-0 ATS TY as AF is on a 8-1 ATS run while Navy has covered 7 of their L/9 TY. AF is actually outrushing Navy on avg 367 (6.0)-363 (6.0) & allowing less (93, 2.9 to 128, 3.8). AF has been outgained the L4Y (-75 ypg). AF is 3-7 as an AD & Navy is 7-4 as a HF incl 2-0 TY w/a avg cover by 15 ypg.

Alabama by 3 over GEORGIA - One of our anticipated SEC gm's of the ssn. Jeremy Pruitt played for and cch'd at Alabama and now is the UGA DC. They last met in the '12 SEC Title gm, when #3 UGA lost to #2 Bama, 32-28 (+7) being outgained 512-394 (UGA ended gm inside Bama's 10, loss cost trip to National Title). UGA beat a FCS tm LW and this clearly will be their toughest test so far. RB Chubb has 12 str 100+ yd gms (tied for most in FBS) but Alabama comes in w/the nation's #4 rush def (57 ypg 2.0). Bama shutout ULM LW 34-0 (won a 4★ LPS play and a 2★ on these pages LW w/ULM +38) needing to get the bad taste of the Ole Miss gm out of their mouths but was looking ahead here. Strength of schedule favors the Tide as they have already faced 2 Top 20 programs (one on road). Bama last was a reg ssn AD in '08, #8 UA beat #3 UGA outright 41-30 (+6) and they are opening as a 1 pt dog this week.

Mississippi by 9 over FLORIDA - The last time these schools met was in '08. Ole Miss pulled the outright upset in the swamp 31-30 (+22) vs #4 UF. Ole Miss is 1-3 but has covered 5 str (Visitor 3 str series wins). Ole Miss as expected LW ply'd klackuster after the Bama upset but beat Vandy (only led 20-16 mid-4Q). UF was fortunate to win LW as they trailed NT 27-14 4Q getting 2 td's in a 2:39 span (LW 1:45). UF is not a HD often and are 1-3 in that role but beat #4 LSU 14-6 (+3) in '12 (last time a SEC HD). Ole Miss is just 3-9 as a AF incl 0-2 LY being outright upset twice in SEC gms. Ole Miss has just NMST on deck so their focus will be on UF while the Gators have a road trip to Mizzou next (MO has beat them by DD's L2Y). The Gators have dealt with 2 str emotional SEC escape wins and pulling a 3rd str against a Top 3 team might be too much to ask even at home.

DUKE by 6 over Boston College - Duke is 2-4 but pulled the outright upset in the L/mtg 20-19 in '11 (+7), their 1st win vs BC s/'27. Duke is off B2B ranked tms beating #20 GT LW in upset fashion 34-20 (+7) but was outgained 316-279. BC bounced bk LW with a misleading 17-14 win over NIU. BC had a 315-153 yd edge (NIU's only td was a 86 yd KR td down 17-7 4Q). BC QB Troy Flutie will be making his 1st career road start & he'll do it against the nation's #10 tt def (all'ing just 261 ypg). BC is on the road for the 1st time TY (4 str HG's), just 1-5 SU/ATS in road openers but did go 3-0 LY as AD's w/2 outright upsets. Duke will be at home for a 4th str wk, playing in front of a Homecoming crowd and are 14-4 as a HF (was upset TY vs #23 NW 19-10 -4). Both schools are playing better than expected and it could be a low scoring affair and a key factor might be BC's #114 off (341 ypg) vs the underrated Duke defense.

Nebraska by 3 over ILLINOIS - NU is 9-2-1 going 2-0 SU/ATS in B10 ply vs Illi w/the avg cover by 11 ppg. UI is 2-19 in B10 openers dropping 4 str ATS. Third str ssn these schools open B10 ply. NU LW outgained SM 611-458 & led 29-7 into the 4Q. UI barely got past MT LW 27-25 (-3) as MT missed a 43-yd fg w/08. UI has won 8 of their L/10 home gms and are 9-4 as a HD. HC Cubit was 4-4 as a HD at WVM but pulled 3 outright upsets. NU has gone 3-1 as a AF but Riley was 1-5 in that role his L5Y at Oregon St. The Illini take a step up in competition against a Husker squad that has already dealt with the "Hail Mary" loss and a 23 pt comeback on the road to force OT.

Ohio St by 21 over INDIANA - Indiana has lost 20 str to OSU s/tie in '90 w/their LW win over OSU in '88. IU however has covered 4 str w/the avg line +29. Visitor is 10-4 ATS. OSU finished its non-conf slate 4-0 as expected but have looked less than stellar at times the L3W (0-3 ATS), still have outgained those foes by 160 ypg. IU comes in 4-0 for the 1st time s/'90 & are on their longest winning streak in 28 yrs, in fact IU is on a 7-2 ATS run. IU has also outscored foes TY 51-0 in the 3Q. IU starts its B10 slate against the #1 tm in the nation, L/time they faced the #1 was in '06, lost 44-3 (+30) vs OSU. HC Meyer's looks like he has settled w/Cardale Jones at the QB spot & might of used the non-conf portion of the schedule to decide that. IU has faced a FCS and a #109 ranked def (other 2; #50 & #19) while OSU brings the nation's #6 unit to Bloomington (all'd 253 ypg) and needs a feel good win to start the B10 ssn.

Northern Illinois by 7 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN - The HT is 11-7 SU/12-6 ATS. CM is the only MAC team to beat NIU in the reg ssn the L/4 yrs, doing it twice ('11 & LY 34-17 +9). CM is off B2B P5 AG's and have faced 3 in non-conf action, plying well going 3-0 ATS. NIU after just a 7-pt loss vs #1 OSU had a misleading final LW, losing 17-14 (+5) at BC being outgained 315-153 (only td a 86 yd KR td). This is CM's HC and only HG in a 4W period while NIU is plying in its 3rd str AG. NIU is 19-4 ATS on the road while CM is 2-8 as a HD.

† Baylor by 21 over Texas Tech - This game will be playing in Arlington. The scoreboard operator may be due for a raise following this B12 shootout. The L4Y these tms have combined to avg 99 ppg. Baylor enters their conf opener following a 70-17 (-33) win over in-state rival Rice as QB Russell tied a schl rec with 6 td passes (on just 16 pass att's) as the Bears put up 793 yds of tt offense! It doesn't seem to matter who the QB is in HC Briles system as both of his previous QB's were NFL DC's and Russell appears to be following their lead. TT put up a valiant effort in their 55-52 (+5) home loss to TCU. On 4&GL from the 4 yd line, TCU's pass was deflected off a WR's hands but it was pulled in by another receiver in the back of the EZ with just :23 left. Baylor has won 4 str in this series (3-1 ATS) after TT had won the prior 15 in a row SU! This may come down to the better D and the Bears have that advantage.

BOISE ST by 28 over Hawaii - Boise returns home here after traveling to UVA and crushing the 'Hoos 56-14 (-2) last Friday, which was their largest MOV ever vs a P5 Cont team. On the 1st play from scrimmage the Broncos ret'd an int 21 yds for a td and never looked back. Highly touted true fresh QB Rypien (nephew of former NFL'r Mark) looked like a seasoned vet in his 1st ever start hitting 24-35-321-3-0 taking over for the injured Ryan Finley, who is out 8 wks with a broken ankle. Boise was up 29-14 at HT and had 447-273 yd & 19-10 FD edges while also being +5 TO's. The Broncos are just 10-18 as a HF but are on a 7-2 ATS run after a Friday gm. We cashed a 3★ LPS as well as a 2★ on these pages LW going against UH as the Rainbow Warriors were shutout for the 2nd time in 3 wks vs a B10 tm, losing 28-0 vs Wisky. UW held a 326-15 rush yd edge and out FD'd UH 31-11. The 'Bows sked has not been kind, with rd trips to OSU, Wisky, and now Boise. BSU is 8-5 ATS vs UH. BSU is 10-17 as a HF, but 34-25 when -20-. UH is 13-19 as a Dog.

Oregon by 7 over COLORADO - Oregon will come into this gm unranked for the first tm since '09. UO's loss to Utah LW was their most lopsided home loss s/'77 vs Washington (54-0). The 62 pts all'd was the most ever all'd in Autzen. QB Adams did return but was replaced due to poor play. UO all'd 530 yards of O and had 3 TO's. The Ducks were down 27-13 at HT but were beaten 35-7 in the 2H. UO has all'd 475 yds of O TY and 301 pass ypg. CU won LW vs an FCS. UO is 4-0 SU and ATS since CU joined the P12, avg score 54-10 (+355 ypg). CU is 3-1 ATS in P12 openers. CU is 28-19-1 as a Dog, but 4-1 as a HD.

Rice does enter this gm off 3 road gms, BUT hasn't left the state of Texas all ssn. In 2013 when they were also off a 3 gm road trip, they returned home and pummeled UTEP as a large home favorite. WKU is on a 12-4 ATS run in conf road gms and the Owls are near the bottom of our pass eff D rankings and the Hilltoppers are avg 400 (73.1%) pass ypg on the season. The Owls can put up a lot of points too however, as they were avg 522 ypg before LW. WKU struggles in all areas on defense, and will come in overconfident after a win over one of the worse MAC teams. The Owls are on a 10-3-1 ATS run and we'll gladly take the home dog here this week. **FORECAST: RICE BY 3**

CALIFORNIA by 18 over Washington St - Cal is 9-1 in this series (6-4 ATS). HT is 2-8 ATS. LW Cal won vs Washington 30-24 (-2). QB Goff went 24-40-342-2-1 while Cal outgd UW 481-259 yds and outFD'd 28-15. Cal also forced 5 TO's. WSU pounded back after losing to an FCS by winning B2B gms over Wyoming and at Rutgers. This is WSU's P12 opener. WSU did win LTH 44-22. WSU is 8-2 as an AD and won outright in their only road trip TY (at Rutgers, +3). Under Leach, WSU is 12-6 as a DD AD. WSU had a bye leading up to this gm. WSU is 3-9 off a bye but 6-6 ATS (LY WSU was 0-2 off a bye SU/ATS) giving up 55 ppg. Cal is 16-6 ATS at home but 2-0 TY as HF.

AUBURN by 27 over San Jose St - AU is on an 0-9 ATS run after losing LW vs Miss St. AU outgd MSST 389-326 and outFD'd 25-18. AU never lead, and was down 14-0 in the 2Q. AU missed four chances in the RZ throughout the gm but an INT, and a missed FG cost them. UA now must regroup as a HF vs SJSt who won LW vs Fresno St (-4). SJSt ran for 291 and passed for 252 and held FSt to 29-88 rush (3.0 ypc). SJSt had allowed 731 rush yds 2 gms prior (one was to AF's triple option). RB Ervin set schl rec with 300 rush yds (most in an FBS gm this ssn). SJSt will have a tough time with the UA pass rush which had 6 sks LW. In '14 AU won vs SJSt 59-13 (-33). AU is 1-6 ATS vs NC Opp. SJSt is 0-5 vs SEC, 1-4 ATS and avg score is 52-12. SJSt is now 0-10 as a Dog!

ARKANSAS ST by 21 over Idaho - LY ASst (-17) won 44-28 despite being -7 TO's. The Red Wolves are 1-3 on the ssn (2-2 ATS) and look to rebound after a poor performance at Toledo LW losing 38-7 (+7). ASst was outgd 477-209 and were -4 TO's for the 2nd time this ssn. ASst actually avg'd less than 1 YPC LW and had just 11 FDs. ASst will try to get their ground game going again vs a poor run defense for ID. LW ID was beaten soundly by Georgia Southern 44-20 (+15). ID all'd 568 yds of O, incl 441 on the ground (8.5 ypc) ID has all'd 314 rush ypg and 7.3 TY. ASst is 22-4 in HG, and 15-6 as a HF. USA is lost 21 str away gms (9-12 ATS) and is 0-4 ATS TY.

LOUISIANA TECH by 17 over UL-Lafayette - These 2 met LY for the first time s/04 with LT (+15) winning outright 48-20. ULL looks to get revenge TY but will have to bounce back after losing to Akron LW (-8) 35-14. ULL led just 14-7 at HT but pulled away in the 2H. ULL was outgd 458-285 and were -3 in TO's. LT won vs FIU (-14) 27-17. RB Dixon had 3 TD's for the 11th time in his car tying the NCAA rec held by Wisconsin's Ball. LT held FIU to just 45 rush yds (2.0 ypc). Dixon may have a field day vs ULL's run D which has all'd 211 ypg (5.1 ypc). LT is 13-5 ATS, and 5-2 in HG's. ULL is 8-2-1 ATS and 13-6 as an AD.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 4 over Vanderbilt - MT won the last time these two met in '04, 17-15. Vandy was competitive vs Ole Miss LW (+26) losing 27-16. Ole Miss was in a letdown spot after being Bama the wk prior and VU almost took advantage. The gm was tied at 13 in the 3Q and VU was within 4 in the 4Q until Ole Miss pulled away. VU was outgd 472-322 and outFD'd 29-21. VU forced Ole Miss to kick 3 FG's while in the RZ as Mason's D continues to play well but a blk punt in the 3Q set up Ole Miss for a short TD drive. MT (+3') had Illinois on the ropes, but a 51 yd GW FG gave the Illini the win. MT's run game was shut down, going 37-38 (1.0 ypc). MT avg's 312 pass ypg but now face Mason's D who has held tms to only 195 pass ypg. VU is 0-6 in AG's and 3-6 vs NC Opp. MT is 12-2 at home (9-5 ATS).

MISSOURI by 6 over South Carolina - Both of these tms dropped a close gm to Kentucky and are looking to rebound in SEC Play. MU once again failed to establish a run LW vs Kentucky losing 21-13 (+3). UM held a 24-18 FD edge but were outgd 369-338. MU has avg'd just 109 rush ypg (3.2 ypc) and comp only 53% of passes. SC (-14') actually trailed UCF 14-8 LW at HF. In the 2H, SC took control behind QB Nunez who was 12-22-184-2 and 18-123 to win 31-14. SC held UCF to just 26 rush yds (1.1 ypc). This was a marked improvement for SC after being gashed in 3 gms for over 200 yds but UCF entered the game with the lowest ranked O in FBS. In '14 MU (+5) won 21-20 and the visitor has pulled B2B upsets. MU is 0-4 ATS but 7-5 as a HT vs SEC and won L3. The Tigers are 13-5 ATS vs SEC tms. SC is 16-8 as a Dog.

LSU by 47 over Eastern Michigan - This is the first meeting. LSU will be heavy fav's for the 2nd wk in a row, this time at home. LW LSU (-24) won 34-24 at Syracuse. Fournette continued his Heisman campaign, running for career high 244 yds, becoming the first RB in LSU history to run for 200+ in B2B. Fournette also had an 87 yd TD run called back by a penalty. LSU held a 425-281 yd edge but did lose FD's 21-17. EMU struggled terribly vs Army's Option O, all'ing 556 rush yds and now must face the hottest RB in the country. EMU (-1') never led vs Army and was beaten 58-36. EMU has all'd 373 rush ypg while LSU runs for 315. LSU is 5-1 as a HF though Miles is 26-35-1. LSU is 3-1 when a -20 or more. EMU is 4-10-1 as an AD and 1-4-1 as an AD when +20 or more. EUM is 0-7 vs SEC, losing by an avg of 49-11.

MARSHALL by 25 over Old Dominion - UM won LW in OT (-7) vs Kent St 36-29. MU trailed 19-7 in the 3Q but scored 2 TDs and eventually won in OT. It's hard to believe UM was in this game as they were actually outgd 436-277 and lost FD's 20-16. MU also had 3 TO's to 1 for Kent St. A 93 yd KR for TD in the 3Q helped spark the rally. MU has been strong on the ground TY avg'ing 166 ypg (4.7 ypc). ODU wasn't so fortunate as they were blown out by Appalachian St 49-0. ODU was outgd 501-175 and outFD'd 24-8 and was -3 TO's. LY MU on the road(-18), led 42-7 at HT and 57-7 before the late 4Q td for the 56-14 final. ODU is avg'ing just 299 yds on O while all'ing 412. MU is 14-1 at home, 10-4-1 ATS. MU is also 10-3-1 ATS as a HF. ODU has yet to cover the spread TY and is on a 2-10 ATS run.

TENNESSEE by 4 over Arkansas - These two teams are desperate for a win after multiple heart-breaking losses. UT has yet to figure out how to finish a game, as UT once again blew a 2 TD 4Q lead LW vs Florida (E) losing 28-27. UT outgained UF 419-392 and outrushed UF 254-109 which was thought to be the difference in the gm. UT all'd a TD with 4:09 then went 3&O. UF was forced into a 4th and 14 but got a 63 yd TD pass. UT had one final chance but barely missed a 55 yd FG. UT has leaned heavily on the run TY, avg'ing 248 ypg (4.7 ypc). The lack of a downfield passing gm has to be a concern though as UT receivers were just 3-17 vs UF and the leading UT receiver has just 98 yds on the ssn. UA lost LW in OT vs Texas A&M 28-21. UA led 21-13 but A&M tied the gm with 2:50 left. UA outgd A&M 457-423 and outFD'd edge. UA has held the yd edge in 2 of 3 losses now but have failed to finish their opportunities like just UT. Jones is 10-8 at home but 1-5 vs SEC as a HF. UA is 2-11 in AG and 4-9 ATS as an AD.

East Carolina by 6 over SMU - ECU is 3-1 (2-2 ATS) but has played two P5 tms tough, losing to UF by 7 and beating VT LW 35-28 (+10). QB Summers was 5-8-110-1 and 21-169-2 rushing. ECU was outgd 439-410 but did have 2 TO's also. ECU has avg'd being outgd 421-397 but SOS has to be accounted for. SMU has also played 2 P5 tms and were beaten by an avg of 56-29. LW SMU was defeated vs an FCS 48-45 as they all'd 729 yds of Total O. That was the third gm SMU has all'd over 700 yds this ssn. In '14 ECU won 45-24 in '14 but was 40 pt Fav. SMU is 4-1 ATS but 2-5 as a HD. ECU is 3-10 ATS and 1-7 as a AF.

SOUTHERN MISS by 14 over North Texas - HT is 0-2 SU/ATS in CUSA play. LW SM was fortunate to be only down 22-0 to Nebraska (+21') at HT after holding forcing NU to kick 5 FG's. SM tried to make the most of an opportunity and cut NU's lead to 29-21 in the 4Q twice and did have one final shot to tie before taking a sk. NT is off a 62-16 beating from Iowa (+24). SM is 2-2, but 4-0 ATS. SM has avg'd 500 ypg while NT all's 498. SM is just 3-17 at home (5-14-1 ATS). NT is 0-3 SU and ATS TY and is on a 2-9 ATS run. NT has been outgained by an avg of 140 ypg TY. NT is 0-8 in AG's (1-7 ATS) but SM is just 1-6-1 as a HF.

South Alabama by 3 over TROY - This will be Troy's first SBC gm under coach Brown. Troy is 2-1 SU with the visitor 2-0-1. LY SA was -14 without their leading rusher and won 27-13. Troy, fresh off a bye is 2-1 SU and ATS. Troy is 4-10 ATS off a bye. Prior to the bye, Troy lost at Wisconsin 28-3 (+34'). Troy struggled in the trenches as can be expected vs The Badgers with just 81 rush yds. On the ssn, Troy has rshed for only 109 ypg (3.8 ypc). USA started fast vs NCST LW (+17') scoring on the first pass to take a 7-0 lead. NCST then blew out the Jags to win 63-13. USA was outgd 586-258 and were -3 TO's. Troy is 5-13 as a HF. USA is on a 3-8-1 run ATS. The Jaguars are just 2-6 as an AD but USA did win TY vs SDSU (+17).

Florida State by 27 over Wake Forest - The 'Noles are 8-1 and 5-4 ATS off a bye. In Wk 3, we had FSU (-7') as our Friday Night Marquee and cashed in as FSU shutout the Eagles 14-0! FSU is 4-6 ATS in ACC play and just 1-5 as a DD Fav vs ACC tms. The L3Y FSU has left nothing to chance as they have won by an avg of 51-2 yielding just 2 fg's. FSU's D has been stout thus far, all'ing 256 ypg and just 116 pass ypg. WF lost LW vs Indiana (+3') 31-24. WF trailed 31-10 in the 4Q but scored 2 late TD's before missing the Onside Kick. WF struggled to run the ball with just 99 yds and 3.1 ypc. FSU is just 2-9 as a DD Fav while WF is 4-2 as a HD under Clawson. WF has lost 11 str vs ranked foes by 29 ppg. USA has a big game on deck vs Miami FL.

Michigan by 17 over MARYLAND - These are 2 tms coming off opposite ends of blowouts. LW on these pages, we had WVU with a 3★ play (-16) vs MD and we were on the money as WVU won easily 45-6. MD was outgd 601-326 and all'd 37 FD's. MD was also -4 TO's. MD has had trouble stopping the run TY, all'ing 209 YPG, 4.5 YPC. MD has run ball well TY but it might be tough sledding against the MU D. LY's gm MD (+6) beat UM 23-16. Mich led 16-9 to start the 4Q. Mich absolutely dominated an exhausted BYU tm LW 31-0. Mich outgained BYU 448-105, winning the FD edge 22-8! UM only all'd 55 pass yds. Mich has run for 202 ypg TY while only all'ing 83 ypg. RB Smith was 16-109-1 but left with an ankle inj (CS). Mich is 9-20 in B10 AG, and 6-10 ATS. MD is 6-1 in Conf Openers. but is 4-1 as a SD Dog, including 4 outright upsets.

UTAH ST by 7 over Colorado ST - The HT is 4-1 ATS in this series and CSU is 3-1. Wells is 6-0 SU and ATS off a bye. UST lost B2B AG vs P5 tms and now plays their MW opener. Prior to the bye, UTSt was beaten by Washington (+7). UST struggled to run the ball, going 30-83 (2.8 ypc). UTSt avg's just 292 ypg and 14 ppg. UTSt's D has been strong TY, all'ing just 107 ypg (2.9 ypc). CSU will try to establish a run as they avg 195 ypg (4.6 ypc). LW CSU (-10) won a close gm vs UTSA 33-31. The yds were almost even but CSU was outFD'd 25-18. CSU all'd 279 rush yds (8.2 ypc). UTSt is 11-6 under Wells vs MW opp and 10-3 as the Fav. Aggies are 2-5 incl a loss LY (-5), 16-13. UTSt is 2-5 as a HF. CSU is 4-2 as an AF but is 3-7 as an AD vs MW tms.

UTEP by 3 over Utsa - This series is off to a surprising start as the visitor has recorded a blowout win in both meetings. LY UTEP (+13) shutout UTSA on the road 34-0. UTEP won LW vs an FCS. UTSA is looking for their first win this season, 2-2 ATS. UTEP is the more veteran tm and Kugler is 6-2-2 ATS as a Fav. LW UTSA dropped a close gm to Colorado ST, 33-31. UTSA RB Williams was 13-170-2 (13.1 ypc). Both tms have struggled on D TY, giving up 43+ ppg. UTEP is all'ing 530 ypg (119th) while UTSA avg's just 20 PPG. UTSA is 4-10 ATS while the Miners are 0-6-1.

NEW MEXICO by 10 over New Mexico St - LY we used NMST as the Underdog POW on #3 of the NCSComp Line and they pulled the outright upset on the road, 34-31. NM (-3) beat WY LW 38-28. The Lobos avg'd 7.4 ypg and had 3 TD's of 40+ yds. NM limited MW leading rusher Hill to just 18-49 after he avg'd 137 rush ypg coming in. NM avg's 262 rush ypg this ssn while NM St all's 234 ypg. NMST is off a bye which has not helped recently, going 0-6 SU and ATS. Prior to the bye, NMST lost a shootout to UTEP 50-47 in OT. NMST actually led by 14 in the 4Q but gave up TDs at 3:08 and 0:42 to push the game to OT. The visitor in this series is 5-2 (6-1 ATS). NM is on an 8-2 ATS run while NMST is 0-8-1 ATS and just 1-10 as an AD under Martin and have gotten beat by a whopping 32 ppg!

NEVADA by 13 over UNlv - NV has dominated this series, going 9-1 (7-3 ATS). LY NV (-9) won on the road 49-27. UNLV has run for 239 ypg but that number is skewed after going for 517 vs an FCS LW in a win which raised their avg 93 ypg. UNLV is now 1-3 but 3-1 ATS this ssn. NV got their 2nd win of the ssn LW at Buffalo (+1) 24-21. Buffalo actually outgd NV 487-379 but NV won the TD battle 3-0. NV dominated the run gm as a tm, going 39-289-3 as both RB's Butler and Jackson ran for over 100 yds. NV is 2-2 SU and ATS on the ssn. NV has also struggled on D, all'ing 480 ypg. NV is 3-9 as a HF and 1-8 as a DD Fav while UNLV is 12-4 as an AD.

SAN DIEGO ST by 14 over Fresno St - FSt has won the L/3 in this series (3-0-1 ATS). LY FSt (-3) had an INT ret set up a TD to win 24-13. FSt comes into this gm 1-3 after getting blowout by SJSt (+4') 49-23. FSt all'd 543 yds of O, 33 FD's and 6.7 ypg. FSt did play without QB Greenlee (susp) and he will be back TW. FSt has struggled on both sides of the ball TY, and avg's just 343 ypg (113th) and 25 ppg while giving up 444 ypg and 45 ppg. FSt is 1-3 both SU and ATS. The Bulldogs are 9-4 as an AD but are 0-2 TY. TY they are on B2B AG's. SDSt has also struggled. The Aztecs are on a 0-5 ATS run. LW SDSt (+15) was beaten by Penn St 37-21. SDSt trailed 27-21 in the 4Q and were driving but a 71 yd FR for TD ended all hopes. SDSt avg's only 294 ypg and 23 ppg. Both tms lone win came vs an FCS.

4★ ATLANTA over Houston - The Falcons overcame a trio of 14 pt deficits against the banged-up Cowboys behind the combination of WR Jones (3rd straight 100+ yd game TY) and RB Freeman (combined for nearly 200 yds rush/rec and 3 TD's). Despite 30-14 FD and 413-318 yd edges, the Texans still needed the aid of some kicking woes by the Bucs (missed PAT & 3 FG's) in their 19-9 victory delivering a Top Play 4★ Newsletter Winner! Unfortunately HOU has yet to deliver a complete game after a pair of late charges in their losses to KC and CAR and scoring the final 13 pts against TB. New HC Quinn has provided some solid improvement so far as ATL became the 1st tm in NFL history to begin 3-0 despite trailing in the 4Q of each contest. That resilience pays off again in this one as the Falcons earn the nod as our Top Weekly Play.

FORECAST: ATLANTA by 14

3★ ARIZONA over St Louis - ARZ delivered one of the easiest NFL GOM Winners in the history of NC Sports as they jumped on SF from the opening whistle and delivered a 47-7 win outgaining the 49ers 446-156 (28-10 FD edge) and forcing 4 Kaepernick int's in the process. ARZ has been a covering machine the past 3 ssn's (25-9-1 ATS) including a 3-0 mark so far in '15. The Rams now head to Arizona with a poor 5-15 ATS mark as a DIV AD. Their matchup against PIT went up in flames as they were held to just 258 yds and 6 pts against a Steelers defense that was allowing 385 ypg heading into the weekend. Judging by their recent history that have seen them help us deliver 3 consecutive LP winners and a pair of 3★'s in this very newsletter, ARZ is an obvious choice for yet another key selection as they've pounded their competition as a HF with a 10-2-1 ATS record.

FORECAST: ARIZONA by 16

OTHER SELECTION

2★ WASHINGTON over Philadelphia - Despite still going through some growing pains on the offensive side of the ball (231 ttl yds), the Eagles were able to get their 1st victory of the ssn (led 24-0 w/2:16 left in 2Q) thanks to RB's Mathews (128 ttl yds, TD) and Sproles (2 TD's incl an 89 yd PR) who were forced into action after RB Murray was a late scratch. The Redskins dropped their TNF matchup a week ago against the Giants as QB Cousins moved to 3-9 as starter (23 TO's). Things are not all bad for WAS however as they are 4th in the NFL in both rushing offense (144 ypg) and defense (75 ypg) and have outgained all 3 of their opponents despite their 1-2 overall mark. WAS has some extra rest heading into this matchup and should have an excellent chance to steal away an upset win against an Eagles squad that is just 2-8 ATS as a DIV favorite and are clearly still in need of some changes on the offensive side of the ball.

FORECAST: WASHINGTON by 3

OTHER GAMES

Baltimore at PITTSBURGH - TNF - Rough spot for both teams heading into TNF as the Ravens are now at 0-3 for the 1st time in franchise history ('96) following their home loss to CIN a week ago despite getting 362 yds in the air from QB Flacco (2nd straight blown lead in the 4Q). PIT was able to move to 2-1 a week ago in a low-scoring matchup with the Rams but the victory may have proven to be costly with QB Roethlisberger being carted off with a knee inj (out 4-6 wks). While the Steelers have covered 5 of their LV regular ssn matchups with the Ravens, BAL did go into Heinz Field twice a ssn ago and pull the outright upset win (TNF in Wk 2 & WC Round of Playoffs). **We'll have one of our Red-Hot Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk (NFL marquees are 15-3, 83% on the ssn!).**

† NY Jets by 4 over Miami - London - This is a 9:30 am EST start. Following big wins in the 1st 2 wks against the Browns and on MNF against the Colts, the Jets came back to reality LW against PKI as they were done in by 4 TO's and trailed 24-0 w/2:16 remaining in the 2Q. The easy early ssn sked hasn't worked out that well for the Dolphins following their home meltdown against BUF (QB Tannehill tossed 3 int's), a game in which they trailed 27-0 at HT against a QB making his 1st career road start. It's been a tough start for the MIA offense as they've been outgained in each of the 1st 3 games while their 6-13-1 ATS mark vs AFC East opponents is equally disappointing. Meanwhile new HC Bowles has the Jets defense firing on all cylinders forcing 11 TO's over the 1st 3 contests (just 12 all of LY) and could ride that group once again here.

INDIANAPOLIS by 14 over Jacksonville - The Colts needed some 4Q magic (21 consec pts) to finally get into the win column LW against the Titans as QB Luck shook off some early struggles (2 int, league-leading 77th turnover dating back to '12) to throw for 260 yds and a pair of late TD's. Despite being outgained 433-378 the Colts nearly moved their AFC South Division mark to an amazing 11-0-2 ATS before the Titans got the backdoor cover w/47 remaining. The Jaguars were hammered by a NE squad leaving it all on the field with a bye on deck as the Patriots had a 471-293 yard advantage and led by 41 pts w/3:00 remaining. This is a tough B2B road situation for the Jaguars as QB Luck has owned them over his 3-yr career with a 5-1 SU/ATS record outscoring JAX by a 30-11 margin in the process.

Carolina by 7 over TAMPA BAY - The Bucs actually took a 9-7 lead to the half a week ago against the Texans before some kicking mistakes saw them blanked for the final 2 quarters in the 19-9 defeat (outgained 413-318). Despite some early hiccups against a Saints squad that was w/o QB Brees, the Panthers took command in the 2H with NO getting a late score for the backdoor cover (CAR 431-380 yd edge). Including LY's playoffs, the Panthers have been on quite the run as they have now delivered wins in 8 of their past 9 contests (only loss came at SEA LY) while outgaining their foes by 89 ypg in the process. Despite lacking some playmakers on the offensive side of the ball following the injury to WR Benjamin, a stingy CAR defense (potential return of LB Kuechly int L/2 w/concussion) and timely offense should see them march on to a 4-0 start in 2015 as the Bucs are just 7-19-1 ATS as an HD.

BUFFALO by 7 over NY Giants - The Bills return home following a dominant performance in MIA that saw them with their biggest HT lead (27-0) since 1992 and delivering a 3★ LP Winner in the process. Some early defensive pressure and ST's helped allow the Giants to get ahead early against WAS. A pair of Manning TD passes in the 4Q proved to be the deciding factor in their 32-21 win (another NFL Marquee Winner!!). While the Giants have covered 7 consecutive games following TNF (s/'95) and have extra rest heading to Buffalo, keep in mind that they have had no resemblance of a running game through their 1st 3 wks of the ssn (yet to reach the 100 yd plateau). They've also blown a pair of DD 4Q leads against DAL and ATL while nearly doing it again a week ago vs WAS. BUF meanwhile has performed well in home contests in '15 against IND/NE and should deliver another quality effort this weekend.

CHICAGO by 3 over Oakland - The Raiders are off to a 2-1 start under new HC Del Rio following their 27-20 win (+3) in CLE that saw them outgain the Browns by a 469-355 clip. The Bears are 0-3 for the 1st time s/'03 following their 26-0 shutout at the hands of a winless Seahawks squad (just 7 FD's and 146 ttl yds w/bkp Clausen making his 1st start of the ssn). While the Bears have been hibernating so far this ssn and have gone just 7-18 as a dog, keep in mind that they have faced 3 of the NFC's elite (GB, ARZ, SEA) and are still in the process of adjusting to the new schemes implemented by the new coaching staff. OAK (dropped 3 of L/4 SU vs CHI) meanwhile is on their 2nd consecutive start at 10am PST which could have them sleepwalking early on in this one.

CINCINNATI by 7 over Kansas City - Some strong performances by QB Dalton (383 yds, 4 ttl TD's) and WR Green (227 yds, 2 TD's) saw the Bengals hold off a late charge and move to 3-0 for the 2nd consecutive ssn while dropping the rivals Ravens to 0-3 in the process. The Chiefs meanwhile are at a schedule disadvantage following their MNF meeting at GB with a potential 1-2 record heading into this matchup. While KC has been fairly tough in road matchups with a 12-5 ATS mark including a nice win over HOU in the opener, CIN has been equally as impressive at home with a 14-3-1 ATS mark (10-3-1 as a HF) and should be expected to get the job done here as their offense has been clicking averaging over 28 ppg.

SAN DIEGO by 11 over Cleveland - Despite a late charge in the 4Q against the Raiders, the Browns' 27-10 deficit was too much to overcome in their 7 pt defeat at home a wk ago (outgained 469-355). SD

meanwhile had a crucial game-changing TO in the 4Q which swung the momentum back to the Vikings in their 31-14 victory (Chargers had a 369-284 yd edge). CLE has actually found some success on trips to CA covering 6 of the L/7 but the key for them in this one will be whether their #32 rush defense (158 ypg all'd) will be able to stop the duo of RB's Gordon and Woodhead along with the rest of the SD offense that's thirsty for a victory after a pair of losses away from home.

Green Bay by 10 over SAN FRANCISCO - The 49ers head home with their tails between their legs after falling victim to a pair of vicious blowouts at the hands of PIT (43-18) and ARZ (47-7). The big issue a week ago was the regression of QB Kaepernick who hit just 9-19 for 67 yds and 4 int's including a pair returned for ARZ TD's (outgained 446-156). GB has delivered SU victories in 9 of their previous 10 contests (7-3 ATS) including a big home win a few weeks back against SEA. While the Packers are on a 12-3-1 ATS run as a favorite, the 49ers have been a HD on just 3 occasions the past 6 seasons (3-0 ATS, including a win in TY's opener vs MIN) and GB is tasked with traveling out West on a short week following their MNF matchup with DET. With no line as of presstime due to GB's Monday tilt, we'll give them a 10 pt advantage and let Vegas determine which way we lean.

DENVER by 10 over Minnesota - The Broncos are off to a 3-0 record for the 2nd time in 3 ssn's following their 12 pt win against DET on SNF, a game in which their rushing defense held the Lions to 28 yds (1.5). MIN meanwhile has held court at home the past 2 wks including a misleading 31-14 win over SD LW (Chargers 369-284 yd edge, key 4Q TO that resulted in a 91 yd IR TD for MIN). The Vikings have lost each of their previous 2 meetings against DEN although both matchups were extremely tight with the Broncos picking up 3 pt wins in the Metrodome (-1' in 2011) and again in OT at home in '07 as a 3 pt dog. While MIN has gone a solid 12-6 ATS as an AD and have found some success prior to their bye week (7-3 ATS), they were embarrassed in their road opener on MNF against SF as a small favorite. The Broncos on the other hand are 17-7 ATS as a HF and have the momentum heading into Wk 4 following a pair of highly-contested road victories.

Dallas at NEW ORLEANS - SNF - The Cowboys and Saints have actually met in 5 of the past 6 ssn's with NO being victorious on 3 occasions. Dallas has now won 10 consecutive road games (8-2 ATS) dating back to the end of '13. They will be without both QB Romo and WR Bryant however in this one. While they had some big leads throughout against the Falcons, DAL was unable to hold on behind bkp QB Weeden (22-26-232-0-1) who lost his 9th consecutive game as a starter (also ended a 6-gm reg ssn win streak by the Cowboys) despite a valiant effort by RB Handle (87 rush yds, 3 TD). The Saints are off to a rocky 0-3 start and could potentially be missing QB Brees once again here (bkp QB McCown 310 yds, int in 5 pt loss to CAR). While some of the big names may be missing due to the injuries in this primetime matchup, there are still plenty of storylines to follow as DAL is still currently in charge of the NFC East and the Saints are clearly at a crossroads after their winless beginning to '15. **Call your VIP Debit Card for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Detroit at SEATTLE - MNF - This marks the 2nd consecutive primetime game for the Lions after they played host to DEN on SNF LW, a game in which their rushing offense failed them once again as they recorded just 28 yds (1.5) on the ground (league-worst 45 ypg TY). The Seahawks meanwhile FINALLY got into the win column in their home opener against the Bears in terrific defensive fashion (CHI 0 pts, 7 FD's, 146 ttl yds). While the dog on ESPN MNF is on a 8-1 ATS run as of presstime, it's never easy to travel to the home of the "12th Man" where the Seahawks have gone 19-7 as a HF.
