## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Ohio St (+) over MICHIGAN** - The biggest rivalry in perhaps all of sports is more commonly referred to as "The Game." OSU is 10-1 SU/7-4 ATS, but the home team is 8-5 ATS & there have been no upsets s/04. The Buckeyes B10 & Nat'l Champ hopes took a huge hit in their 17-14 (-14) home loss to MSU LW. OSU was held to ssn lows in FD's (5), rush (86) & pass (46) yds, while the 132 tl yds was the least ever by an Urban Meyer cch'd team. The Bucks finished -162 yds, but still never trailed the entire gm until the GW fg as time expired. OSU is #7 in FBS all'g 101 ypg less than their foes avg. UM still has a chance to win the B10 East Div & enter off a 28-16 (-3') win at PSU as they finished +136 yds. The Wolves are #3 in FBS all'g 127 ypg less than what their foes avg. Against 6 common foes (IU, MD, PSU, RU, MN, MSU) OSU is 5-1 SU/3-3 ATS, +18 ppg & +80 ypg. UM is 5-1 SU/3-3 ATS, +13 ppg & +67 ypg. UM is 2-6 SU/3-5 ATS in home finales & 5-8 ATS off a SU win. OSU is 8-2 as an AD incl 7-0 as a conf AD & HC Meyer is 6-0 as a dog at OSU.

**FORECAST: OHIO STATE BY 8**

**3★ Oklahoma over OKLAHOMA ST** - 110th Bedlam! OU is 10-2 SU but has failed to cover 3 of the L/4. Cowboys haven't won B2B in this series s/01 & '02. LY OSU pulled a huge outright upset over #18 OU in OT 38-35 (+21) after trailing 28-14 at HT. OU had a 424-385 yd & 21-18 FD edge. LW the Sooners survived a scare from TCU who were w/o QB Boykin & WR Dotson. OU was +146 yds, +12 FD's & +3 TO's but needed a stop on a 2PT to win the gm 30-29 (-17). The Sooners appeared to be in control but lost QB Mayfield (concussion, CS) in the 2Q. OU needs to beat their in-state rivals to win the B12. LW OSU lost to Baylor 45-35 (pk). OSU all'd a ssn high in yds (700) & rush yds (304). The Cowboys also all'd 396 pass yds despite BU being down to their 3rd string qb in the 2H. OU is +207 ypg in B12 play while OSU is +21 ypg in B12. OU is #16 in FBS avg 107 ypg more than their foes allow & #2 in FBS all'g 129 ypg less than their foes avg. OU is 13-6 ATS away & 8-3 ATS overall. A win will likely get them into the playoffs & look for them to make a statement.

**FORECAST: OKLAHOMA BY 14**

**3★ Alabama over AUBURN** - 80th Iron Bowl. Bama is 5-2 SU in this series. While Bama won LY, they still haven't forgotten about their last trip to the Plains when they lost via the infamous "kick six." Bama enters off a win over FCS Charleston Southern, 56-6 (-38'). LW Aub secured a bowl bid after their 56-34 (-34) home win over ID. AU actually led 56-20 in the 4Q but ID scored 2 late td's. Against 6 common foes (LSU, MSU, Ark, UM, A&M, UGA) Bama is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS, +15 ppg & +107 ypg, while AU is 1-5 SU/ATS, -5 ppg & -27 ypg. AU is -26 ypg at home while Bama is +231 ypg on the road. Bama is #1 in FBS all'g 163 ypg less than their foes avg. AU is 2-14 ATS overall. Bama won't take any chances this year & are playing perhaps the best of anyone in the country right now.

**2★ New Mexico ST (+) over Arkansas ST** - Just the 3rd mtg s/03. LY ASU only led 27-21 at HT but went on to win 68-35 (-23') w/ an SBC rec 764 yds (+272 yds & 34-22 FD edge). ASU enters undefeated in conf play & are fresh off a bye & a 59-21 (-14') win at ULM the wk prior. The Red Wolves had a ssn high 300 pass yds & all'd ssn lows in FD's (10), pass (100) & tl (252) yds & finished +196 yds. NMST has won 3 str gms for the first time s/04, after upsetting ULL 37-34 (+15'). The best RB you never heard of is Larry Rose III. He led the way with 191 yds & now has 6 gms over 180 rush yds on the ssn! QB Allen, who actually started the ssn as a WR, threw 4 tds. ASU is -17 ypg away, but +76 ypg in SBC action. **OREGON by 42 over Oregon State** - This rivalry game is known as "Civil War" & the Platypus trophy is at stake. UO is 7-0 SU/5-2 ATS in this series, but the visitor is 8-1 ATS. UO enters having won 6 of 7 incl 5 str after their 48-28 (-4) home win over USC LW. The Ducks had a ssn high 407 pass yds & their 578 ttl yds was the most USC has all'd (193 yds more than they allow on avg) & finished +154 yds. Their offense is locked in s/the return of QB Adams. UO is #8 FBS avg 131 ypg more than their foes allow, but are #100 in FBS all'g 46 ypg more than their foes avg. OSU enters having lost 9 of 10 incl 8 str after their 52-7 (+15) loss in their home finale to UW LW. The Beavers had a ssn low 8 FD's & finished -225 yds. They've all'd 270+ rush yds in 3 str gms, are #107 in FBS avg 69 ypg less than their foes allow & are #110 in FBS all'g 60 ypg more than their foes avg. Sked edge favors OSU has UO is off huge gms vs SU & USC. Oregon is 5-1 SU/1-4-1 ATS in home finales (0-3 ATS vs OSU in that role), but 14-2 ATS vs P12 foes, while OSU is 4-19 ATS overall & 3-10 ATS off a SU loss.

**Boise St by 10 over SAN JOSE ST** - BSU is 5-0 SU in this series, but this is the 1st mtg as MW foes. BSU enters having lost not only B2B gms, but B2B home gms following their 37-30 (-11) loss to AF. The Broncos all'd a ssn high 607 yds & finished -229 yds. It's the 1st time s/97 that BSU has lost consecutive home gms. SJSt must win to become bowl elig & is off a 42-23 (-10) win at Haw LW. The Spartans finished +94 yds & have gained 433+ yds in 3 of their L/4 gms, but have all'd 205+ rush yds in 4 of their L/5 gms. Against 5 common foes (AF, BYU, UH, UNLV, NM) BSU is 2-3 SU/ATS, +11 ppg & +2 ypg. SJSt is 3-2 SU/4-1 ATS, +3 ppg & +15 ypg. SJSt is 2-11 ATS as a dog, while BSU is 8-3 ATS after a Fri gm & 29-13 as an AF.

**Baylor by 3 over TCU** - This is the 111th version of "The Revivalry," that dates back to 1899! BU has won 3 of 4 SU, but TCU is 6-1 ATS. BU never led LY until their GW 28 yd fg w/no time left, which capped off a 21 pt deficit. BU rebounded from their 1st loss of the ssn to hand OSU its 1st loss in their 45-35 (pk) win at OSU LW. The Bears had a conf ssn high 700 ttl yds (most OSU has all'd, 307 yds above their avg!), all'd a ssn low 8 rush yds & finished +259 yds. BU is #2 in FBS avg 182 ypg more than their foes allow & still have a chance to win the B12 & reach the playoffs. TCU enters having lost 2 of 3 following their 30-29 (+17) loss at OU LW. The Horned Frogs were w/o QB Boykin & WR Dotson, but down 23-7 at HT, battled back in the 2H & were a missed 2 pt conv at the end from pulling the outright upset. TCU was held to ssn lows in FD's (16) rush (161) & ttl (390) yds & all'd a ssn high 333 rush yds & finished -146 yds. They are #6 in FBS avg 149 ypg more than their foes allow. BU is +233 ypg away & +148 ypg in B12 action, while TCU is +283 ypg at home & +158 ypg in conf play. TCU is 8-2 SU/7-3 ATS in home finales & 15-8 ATS overall, but 4-10 ATS in weekday gms, while BU is 5-3 ATS in weekday gms.

**APPALACHIAN ST by 21 over UL Lafayette** - ULL will be ply'g w/vengeance after their loss in LY's initial mtg cost them a share of the SBC crown. App St still has a shot at winning the SBC, enter fresh off a bye & rebounded from their 1st conf loss w/a 47-20 (-20) at ID the wk prior. Excluding their FCS gm, the Mountaineers had ssn highs in FD's (29) & rush yds (401) & finished +212 yds. They limited ID to a ssn low 299 yds. App St is #17 in the FBS all'g 72 ypg less than their foes avg, are +111 ypg at home & +150 ypg in SBC action. ULL must win out to become bowl elig for a 5th str ssn. The Ragin Cajuns enter off a 37-34 (-15) home loss to NMSU LW. They all'd 10 pts the L/4 min incl the GW 21 yd fg w/1:29 left. ULL had a ssn high 285 pass yds, but all'd a ssn high 498 ttl yds & finished -123 yds. The Cajuns are -15 ypg away & -24 ypg in conf play. App St is 9-3 ATS vs SBC foes & 2-0-1 ATS off a bye, but ULL is 19-10 as an AD.

**Louisville by 3 over KENTUCKY** - This in-state rivalry is ply'd for the Governors Cup. UL is 11-5 SU/9-6-1 ATS & the visitor is 5-1-1 ATS. LY was the 1st time in 19 mtgs that the team with the least rush yds won this gm. UL enters avg 146 (4.0) rush ypg, while all'g 121 (3.3). UK enters avg 169 (4.9) rush ypg, while all'g 185 (4.3). UK must win to become bowl elig & snapped their 5 gm losing streak in their 58-10 (-24) home win over Charlotte LW. The Wildcats had ssn highs in rush (415) & ttl (544) yds, all'd ssn lows in pass (87) & ttl (233) yds & finished +311 yds. UK is +39 ypg at home. UL had their 4 gm win streak snapped in their 45-34 (+1) loss at Pitt LW. The Cards were held to 1 rush yds & all'd a ssn high 244 rush yds & finished -122 yds. The 476 yds all'd was the most by Pitt all ssn. UL is -4 ypg away. UK is 1-6 ATS overall & 1-9-2 as a HD, while UL is 9-4-1 ATS vs non-conf foes, 15-6 ATS off a SU loss & 9-5 away from LVille.

**MICHIGAN ST by 7 over Penn St** - This gm has huge B10 & Nat'l implications for MSU, who must win to earn a trip to the B10 Champ gm next wk. PSU is 8-4 SU in this series & the home team is 10-5 SU/9-5 ATS, but the visitor has won 3 in a row SU. We easily cashed our Totals GOY on the UNDER (53) in MSU's huge 17-14 (+14) road upset at OSU LW! Q Cook DNP (Shoulder, CS TW) as Sparty had a ssn low 91 pass yds, but they all'd ssn lows in FD's (5) pass (46) & ttl (132) yds & finished +162 yds. MSU took their only lead w/no time left after hitting the GW fg. In MSU's 2 road wins at UM & OSU, Sparty never led in regulation as they took the lead in both gms w/no time left on the clock! MSU is #10 in FBS all'g 92 ypg less than their foes avg. PSU will look to play spoiler & enter off a 28-16 (+3) home loss to UM. The Nittany Lions all'd a ssn high 256 pass yds & finished -136 yds. PSU is #22 in FBS all'g 72 ypg less than their foes avg. Against 5 common foes (RU, IU, OSU, MD, UM) MSU is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS, +13 ppg & +115 ypg. PSU is 3-2 SU/2-3 ATS, +2 ppg & +2 ypg. MSU is 4-1 SU in home finales, 2-7 ATS as a fav & 4-7 ATS overall, but PSU is 0-4 ATS off a SU loss.

**EAST CAROLINA by 3 over Cincinnati** - UC has won 4 in row SU in this series by 16 ppg (4-1 ATS). The home team is 7-1 ATS & EC is ply'g w/vengeance. We easily cashed our Thurs night Marquee w/EC in their 44-7 (-14) road win at UCF LW! The Pirates finished w/ssn highs in yds (622) & FD's (31) while all'g ssn lows in yds (232) & FD's (12) & QB Kemp's 465 pass yds was 2nd most in sch'l history! EC must win to gain bowl elig. UC has alternated wins & losses their L/4 gms & was officially eliminated from the conf champ gm following their 65-27 (-2) road loss at USF last Fri. The Bearcats were down 51-3 at HT. St'g QB Keil was benched in the embarrassing loss. The Pirates are -50 ypg at home, but +34 ypg in AAC action. UC is +40 ypg away & +185 ypg in conf play. EC is 7-2 ATS when seeking revenge & 13-6-1 as a HD, but UC is 5-2 as an AF, 11-2 ATS in the 2nd gm of B2B road trips & 20-13 ATS off a SU loss.

**TEMPLE by 14 over Connecticut** - TU is 3-1 SU/8-1 ATS in this series, but the visitor is 3-0 SU/ATS & there have been 3 outright upsets the L/4. 4 of the L/6 gms have been decided by 7 pts or less. TU will likely have to win to remain in 1st place in the AAC East Div & earn a spot in the conf champ gm next wk. The Owls have alternated W's & L's their L/5 gms & enter off a 31-12 (+2) home win over Mem LW. TU held UM to a ssn low 232 yds (309 yds below their avg) & finished +229 yds. UC enters on a 3 gm win streak incl a huge upset over previously undefeated Houston at home, 20-17 (+10). The Huskies also had a huge effort on D, holding UH to a ssn low 318 yds (194 yds below their avg), but finished -3 yds as they were +4 in TO's. Against 5 common foes (UCF, USF, UC, ECU, Tulane) TU is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS, +10 ppg & -6 ypg. UC is 3-2 SU/2-3 ATS, +4 ppg & -2 ypg. UC is 6-10 ATS as a dog, while TU is 12-4 ATS overall, but 0-3 SU/ATS in home finales.

**WEST VIRGINIA by 7 over Iowa St** - WV is 2-1 SU/ATS in this series as B12 rivals, but the visitor is 3-0 SU/ATS. ISU enters having lost 6 of 7 incl 3 str after their 38-35 (+3) loss at KSU. The Cyclones led 35-14 at HT, but were shutout in the 2H & HC Rhoads will be fired after this gm. ISU all'd the GW 42 yd fg w/0:3 left, but finished +63 yds. ISU is -91 ypg away & -53 ypg in B12 action. WV has won 3 str & became bowl elig following their 49-0 (-28) road shutout at KU LW in a mostly empty stadium. The Mountaineers had 3 players rush for 100+ yds for the 1st time s/69 as they finished w/ssn highs

in rush (426) & ttl (630) yds. WV all'd ssn lows in FD's (10) & ttl yds (221) & finished +409 yds. The Mountaineers are #13 in FBS all'g 80 ypg less than their foes avg. WV is +133 ypg at home, but -10 ypg in conf play. WV is 8-15 as a HF, while ISU is 5-8 ATS away vs B12 foes.

**WAKE FOREST by 1 over Duke** - WF had won 12 in a row SU, but Duke has now won 3 in a row SU in this series, while WF is 11-5-1 ATS. We cashed a 2★ on these pages LW (college ★'s now 36-17, 68% L9W!) going against Duke in their 42-34 (+2) loss at UVA. The Blue Devils had a ssn high 385 pass yds, but all'd UVA to gain a ssn high 502 yds (136 yds above their avg) & finished -17 yds. WF enters having lost 7 of 8 incl 5 str after their 33-13 (+29) loss at Clem LW. The Demon Deacons all'd ssn highs in pass (381) & ttl (552) yds & finished -400 yds! WF is #115 FBS avg 69 ypg less than what their foes allow. Duke is +72 ypg away, but -49 ypg in ACC action, while WF is +32 ypg at home, but -133 ypg in conf play. WF is 10-3 as a HD, but Duke is 12-3 SU away, 22-10 ATS away & 21-13-1 ATS overall.

**Indiana by 10 over PURDUE** - Old Oaken Bucket at stake as these schls have met in their reg ssn finale every yr but twice s/1920! IU is 1-7 SU/2-6 ATS at PU. We used IU as not only our underdog POW on these pages LW (5th outright upset TY!) but also as a 3★ LPS play on Sat (college LPS now 27-10, 73% L7W!) in their 47-28 (+2) win at MD. The win snapped a 6 gm losing skid as the Hoosiers finished +66 yds & are now a win away from becoming bowl elig for the 1st time s/07! IU is #11 in FBS avg 118 ypg more than their foes allow, but #124 in FBS all'g 119 ypg more than their foes avg, are -55 ypg away & -67 ypg in B10 Action. We also cashed a 3★ LPS play on PU in their 40-20 (+22) loss at undefeated Iowa. The Boilermakers never trailed ATS & finished +18 yds! PU is #106 in FBS all'g 47 ypg more than their foes avg, are -104 ypg at home & -118 ypg in conf play. PU is 4-13 as a HD, while IU is 5-2 ATS as a fav.

**Florida Atlantic by 1 over OLD DOMINION** - FAU will be ply'g w/vengeance after losing their initial mtg on a fg w/no time left LY. FAU enters having lost 6 of 7 incl 3 str, but are off an emotional 20-14 (+29) OT loss at SEC East Div champ Florida! Scoreless at HT, FAU all'd two 3Q td's, but stormed back to tie it up mid 4Q. After a tie in OT, the Owls blk'd the PAT, but on their possession got a 1&gl at the 9, but then was sk'd & threw 3 str inc. FAU finished +47 yds & held UF to 252 yds (lowest output of the ssn, 119 yds below their avg)! ODU will be ply'g to become bowl elig after they failed LW in their 56-31 (+21) loss at SM. The Monarchs all'd ssn highs in FD's (33), rush (310) & ttl (612) yds & finished -274 yds. ODU is #104 in FBS all'g 46 ypg more than their foes avg. Against 5 common foes (Char, MU, UTEP, FIU, WKU) FAU is 2-3 SU/2-1 ATS, -4 ppg & -57 ypg. ODU is 2-3 SU/1-4 ATS, -12 ppg & +63 ypg. Sked edge favors ODU, who is 6-0 SU in home finales, while FAU is travelling for the 4th time in 6 wks. ODU is 2-9 ATS overall & 1-11 ATS at home. The dog is 17-3-1 in FAU gms & the Owls are 18-7-1 ATS away.

**TENNESSEE by 21 over Vanderbilt** - This rivalry started in 1892 & this is the 109th mtg! UT is 29-3 SU, but the visitor is 7-4 SU/ATS & VU has cov'd 3 str. UT enters having won 5 of 6 incl 4 str after their 19-8 (-7) win at MO LW. The Vols were held to a ssn low 89 pass yds, but excluding their FCS gm, all'd ssn lows in FD's (10) & rush yds (88) & finished +114 yds. VU enters having lost 3 of 4 incl being shutout 25-0 (+6) LW at home vs A&M. The 'Dores were held to ssn lows in FD's (10), pass (23) & ttl (148) yds, while all'g ssn highs in pass (336) & ttl (486) yds. VU is #112 in FBS avg 72 ypg less than their foes allow, but are #21 in FBS all'g 73 ypg less than their foes avg. Against 5 common foes (UGA, SC, MO, UF, UK) VU is 2-3 SU/4-1 ATS, -4 ppg & -27 ypg. UT is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS, +11 ppg & +74 ypg. HC Jones is 1-5 as a HF vs SEC foes, while VU is 10-2 ATS w/conf revenge & 12-5 as an AD.

**GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 24 over South Alabama** - Big gm for both schls as SA is trying to become bowl elig, while GS is still alive for the SBC crown. SA will also be ply'g w/vengeance after being embarrassed by over 3 td's LY. SA enters off a 24-10 (+2) loss at GS LW. They were held to just 284 yds & finished -100 yds, but they did allow under 100 rush yds for the 2nd str gm. GS nearly pulled a monumental upset over UGA LW, falling 23-17 (+13) in OT. GS all'd the gm tying fg w/6:06 left, but was SOD in OT & then all'd a 25 yd td run on UGA's 1st pt. The Eagles finished just -36 yds. GS is #11 in FBS all'g 87 ypg less than their foes avg, are +205 ypg at home & +157 ypg in SBC action. SA is +4 ypg away & +15 ypg in conf play. After all'g the GS triple option 335 rush yds (6.4) & Navy 388 (7.2) LY, the Jag's next 2 gms are against the option & will have their attention. GS is 5-3 as a HF, while SA is 2-7 as an AD.

**WYOMING by 4 over Univ - WY** is 7-2 SU & the home tm is 5-1 SU/6-2 ATS in this series, but the last mtg was in '12. Both tms ply'g for pride. We cashed a 3★ on these pages (college ★'s now 36-17, 68% L9W!) as well as our college 900 Marquee POD (college Marquee's now 22-11, 67% L6W!) going against UNLV in their 52-14 (+16) home loss to SDSU. The Rebels were held to a ssn low 80 rush yds & had been avg 512 ttl ypg their prev 3 gms, but were held to just 270 & finished -123 yds. UNLV is #114 in FBS all'g 70 ypg more than their foes avg. WY is fresh off a bye & a 38-3 (+24) loss at SDSU the wk prior, their 4th str loss. The Pokes were held to ssn lows in FD's (12) & yds (191) & finished -240 yds. Against 4 common foes (NV, BSU, CSU, SDSU) UNLV is 1-3 SU/ATS, -18 ppg & -104 ypg. WY is 1-3 SU/2-2 ATS, -17 ppg & -113 ypg. UNLV is 11-5 ATS away, while WY is 1-3 SU/0-4 ATS off a bye, 1-9 ATS in their home finale & 2-10 ATS at home vs MW foes.

**Middle Tennessee by 10 over UTSA** - 1st mtg. MT enters having won 4 of 5 incl 3 str & is off an important 41-7 (-23) home win over NT LW that made them bowl elig for a 4th str yr. Excluding their FCS gm, the Blue Raiders finished w/a ssn high 30 FD's & finished +170 yds. MT is #25 in FBS avg 70 ypg more than their foes allow. UTSA enters off a misleading 34-24 (-3) home win over Rice LW. The Roadrunners finished -89 yds & -10 FD's, but were +3 TO's. UTSA is #110 in FBS avg 69 ypg less than their foes allow. MT is -63 ypg away, but +107 ypg in CUSA action, while UTSA is -110 ypg at home & -81 ypg in conf play. UTSA is 4-0 SU/3-0 ATS in home finale & 3-1 as a HD, while MT is 3-7 ATS on the conf road.

**UTAH by 17 over Colorado** - This is the 5th str yr ply'g in the reg ssn finale. UT has won the L/3 SU but is 0-4 ATS in the series. LY won 38-34 (-9). Utah is coming off a 17-9 (pk) home loss to UCLA. The Utes were outg'd 325-307 but did hold a 23-18 FD edge. In Utah's L/5 poss, they had four 3 & outs and fmb'd at the UCLA 33. The loss eliminates the Utes from P12 South contention. CU is coming off a 27-3 (+15) loss at WSU. CU was outg'd 481-323 & outFD'd 30-17 despite QB Falk leaving with an inj (CS). CU is -99 ypg in P12 play while Utah is +22 ypg in P12 play. Against 6 common foes (UO, ASU, AZ, OSU, UCLA, USC), CU is 1-5 SU/4-2 ATS, -9 ppg & -65 ypg while Utah is 3-3 SU/2-4 ATS, +7 ppg & +39 ypg. Utah is 4-9 ATS in conf home gms, but CU is 5-11 ATS away.

**UTAH ST by 1 over BYU** - 85th mtg. BYU is 10-1-4-8 ATS. The visitor has cov'd 4 str. BYU is coming off a 52-10 (-26) home win over Fresno St. BYU held 520-275 yd & 22-17 FD edges. UTSt became bowl eligible after their 31-27 (-15) home win over Nevada LW. The Aggies held a 313-264 yd edge. UTSt trailed 27-7 in the 3Q before rallying to score 24 str pts. BYU is -72 ypg on the road while UTSt is +90 ypg at home. BYU is 2-6 ATS vs MW foes, while UTSt is 14-8 ATS at home.

**Virginia Tech by 7 over VIRGINIA** - This is for the Commonwealth Cup. VT has absolutely dominated this series, winning 11 str (8-2 ATS). LY both tms came in 5-6 and needed to win to go to a bowl. UVA took a 20-17 lead in the 4Q but VT went 75 yds to get the deciding td & win 24-20 (+1). LW UVA got a home win over Duke, 42-34 (-2). QB Johns threw for a car high 344 yds & 2 tds in the win. UVA got 2 SOD's deep in their own territory late in the 4Q to secure the win. VT is coming off a tough 30-27 (+4) OT loss to NC. VT was outg'd 445-403 but came up with 2 late scores to tie. VT will get one more crack to send HC Beamer out with a bowl gm. VT is +69 ypg away while UVA is -21 ypg at home. UVA is 13-4 ATS as a dog incl 6-2-1 as a HD, while VT is 3-8 as an AF.

**North Carolina by 1 over NC STATE** - In the L/17y there have been 12 outright upsets in this rivalry. NCSt is 6-2 SU/ATS in the series and was 5-0 from '07-'11 but in Fedora's F/2Y NC went 2-0 SU/ATS. LY NCSt dominated and won 35-7 (+6). NC comes in as one of the hottest tms in the country, having won 10 str. That win streak almost ended LW at VT. NC led 21-7 late in the 4Q but all'd VT to tie before NC got a 30-27 (-4) OT win. RB Hood went over 100 rush yds for the 6th time on the ssn & had 2 tds. The Tar Heels will have to make sure they don't look past NCSt to the ACC Title Game. NCSt won LW 42-29 (-17) at home vs Syracuse. The Wolfpack put up their 2nd highest yds of the ssn (511) & held SU to their 3rd lowest output of the ssn (292). NCSt is +91 ypg on the ssn but -13 ypg in ACC play. NC is +106 ypg & +85 ypg in ACC play. NC is #9 FBS avg 120 ypg more than their foes allow while NCSt is holding their foes to 46 ypg less than their avg' on the ssn. NC is 5-2 ATS vs ACC foes & 3-1 as an AF, but NCSt is 9-5 ATS overall.

They were penalized for being offside during the offense attempt that ensued. BC finished -145 yds, but were +4 in TO's. They're #123 in FBS avg 103 ypg less then their foes allow, but are #4 in FBS all'g 131 ypg less then their foes avg. SU has lost 8 str after their 42-29 (+17) loss at NCSt LW. The Orange finished -219 yds & are #120 in FBS all'g 96 ypg more than their foes avg. Against 5 common foes (FSU, WF, CU, UL, NCSI) BC is 0-5 SU/1-3-1 ATS, -10 ppg & -106 ypg, while SU is 1-4 SU/2-3 ATS, -11 ppg & -195 ypg. BC is 4-7-1 ATS overall. Our Underdog POW has had B2B outright upset winners here & series history points to another here.

Rice's is 7-0 SU/5-2 ATS in home finales. Charlotte is playing B2B road gms to end the ssn. Rice is 17-7-1 as a HF.

**RUTGERS by 3 over Maryland** - RU has won the L/2 vs MD incl LY's 41-38 (+8) win. RU trailed 35-10 in the 2Q before making the largest comeback in schl history. LW MD lost at home to Ind 47-28 (-2) and we cashed in on another 3★ LPS Selection. The Terps all'd UI to score on 7 str poss after taking a 21-3 lead. RB Ross (19-250-3) was a big reason they were even in the gm. MD did play w/o QB Hills (Mono, CS) then lost backup QB Rowe (Concussion, CS) at HT. RU got a win over Army LW, 31-21 (-4). LY UF settled for 3 FG's to take a 9-0 lead but FSU got a 94 yd IR td & scored 21 str. Visitor is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS. FSU got a breather LW against FCS Chattanooga, winning 52-13 (-30'). The Gators appeared to have an easy gm as well but FAU did not cooperate. The Gators were outgd' 299-253, outFD'd 18-13 but got the OT win, 20-14 (-29). The Gators Off was held to their 2nd lowest tt yds on the ssn & 177 yds less than they avg. UF is +80 ypg at home & the UF Def has held foes to 123 ypg less than they avg. However, the UF Off has struggled, avg'g 23 ypg less than their foes have all'd on the ssn. FSU is -51 ypg on the road & the FSU Off has avg'd 77 ypg more than their foes have all'd on the ssn. FSU is 10-15 ATS overall, while UF HC McElwain is 28-11-1 ATS overall. This is UF's home finale.

**Georgia by 6 over GEORGIA TECH** - UGA is 12-2 SU/9-4-1 ATS in the series. UGA will be out for revenge after GT won LY 30-24 (+10) & danced in the center of the field on the 'G'. GT hasn't won 2 in a row in the series s/'00. UGA barely avoided a disaster LW in a 23-17 (-13') OT win over Georgia Southern in their home finale. The Bulldogs held +36 yds & +6 FD edges. The good news for UGA is that they got to prepare for the option against GS. Georgia held GS to their 3rd lowest yds (277) & rush yds (233) of the ssn. RB Michel (23-132-1) came up big to help the Bulldogs avoid the upset. GT is coming off a 38-21 (-2) loss at Miami LW. GT is guaranteed to have their worst ssn s/'94 (1-10). GT is +110 ypg at home while UGA is -69 ypg on the road. UGA is 3-8 ATS overall and 0-2 as an AF TY incl being an outright upset. GT is 1-8 ATS overall vs FBS foes, but 7-1 ATS as a dog. This is GT's home finale.

**LSU by 14 over Texas A&M** - A&M has lost 4 str incl 0-3 SU/ATS in SEC play. LY LSU won 23-17 (-3) the wk after being shutout. Tigers had a 491-228 yd & 25-12 FD edge. LW A&M got their 8th win of the ssn at Vandy, 25-0 (-6). The shutout win was their 1st s/'04 (Wyoming). A&M held Vandy to ssn lows in yds (148) & pass yds (23). A&M's offense picked up 486 yds but struggled to get the ball in the EZ but K Bertolo went 6-6 on fg's. QB Murray did bounce back from a few poor performances to throw for 336 yds but did so on 50% comp. LSU lost their 3rd str gm LW for the 1st time s/'99. Ole Miss jumped out to a 24-0 lead in the 1H. LSU did make it 24-17 in the 3Q. The Tigers actually ended the gm +76 yds & +4 FD's but the early deficit got them out of their gm plan & QB Harris threw 51 passes. LSU is +141 ypg at home while A&M is +40 ypg on the road. LSU is 5-1 SU in home finales but is on a 1-10 ATS run. LSU is 7-3-1 as a HF, while A&M is 1-5 ATS overall & 3-7 ATS away vs SEC foes.

**Illinois by 3 over Northwestern** - Played at Solider Field in Chicago, IL (home of the NFL Bears). Second neutral site mtg s/'10 (Wrigley Field; home of MLB Cubs). Revenge gm for NU as LY UI pulled the outright upset 47-33 (+8) w/438-372 yd & 23-19 FD edges. Both came in 5-6 in the bowl elimination gm. This ssn NW comes in bowl eligible but UI must win to get there. LW UI lost 32-23 (+5) at Minn. The Illini outgd' Minn by 90 yds & held a +10 FD edge. UI trailed 24-23 in the 4Q but all'd a 75 yd td run. NW is off a misleading win over UW, 13-7 (+10). NW benefitted from 5 UW TO's & still almost lost when UW got to the NW11 late in the 4Q but was SOD's. NW avg's 21 ypg on the ssn while UI avg's 27 ypg. NW's Def has all'd 74 ypg less than their foes avg on the ssn but the Off has avg'd just 52 ypg less than their foes have all'd. NW is 17-32-1 ATS as a fav, but UI is 12-20 ATS as a dog & 11-20 vs conf foes.

**CALIFORNIA by 7 over Arizona State** - ASU is 2-8 SU/4-6 ATS but did win 27-17 (-2), snapped 4 gm series losing streak in the L/mtg (12). Cal is 0-3 SU/ATS in home finales. Cal is coming off a 35-22 (+9) loss in The Big Game at Stanford. Cal was +139 yds & +7 FD's but settled for 3 fg's in the RZ which made the difference & SU also got a KR td. Cal held SU to a ssn low 356 yds & 96 passing yds. LW we used ASU as a 4★ LPS Selection (27-10 L7 wks) & the Sun Devils came through with a 52-37 (-7) win! The victory made ASU bowl eligible. ASU led from the start and 'Zona actually added a late td. The Sun Devils held 565-449 yd & 24-19 FD edges. Cal is +66 ypg on the ssn & +86 ypg at home while ASU is +39 ypg & -44 ypg on the road. Cal avg 109 ypg more than their foes allow. ASU is 3-8-1 as an AD. Cal is 1-4 ATS s/their bye.

The Vandals are coming off a 56-34 (+34) loss at Auburn. The Vandals trailed 56-20 before scoring 2 late tds but did outgain Aub 479-460. ID is -19 ypg at home while TXSt is -280 ypg on the road. ID's offense has avg 11 ypg more than their foes have all'd on the ssn while TXSt's D all's foes to avg 118 ypg more than they have avg'd. ID has dropped 4 str Kibbie Dome finales (2-7 ATS). **Clemson by 17 over SOUTH CAROLINA** - 113th mtg. LY the Tigers snapped their series high 5 gm losing skid w/ a 35-17 (-6) win. CU had a 491-339 yd edge (+2 FD). CU won as expected LW, 33-13 (-29) at home vs WF. The Tigers held WF to 152 yds which was their 2nd lowest of the ssn. CU's 552 yds was the most WF has all'd on the ssn, and that was the 6th out of the L/7 that CU gained more yds than their foes all'd all year. SC is coming off an embarrassing 23-22 (-20) loss to The Citadel. Clemson is +222 ypg & +257 ypg on the road while SC is -64 ypg & -138 ypg at home. SC has won 7 str home finales riding a 8-1 ATS streak also. CU is 2-5 as an AF, while SC is 5-1 as a HF.

**NORTH TEXAS by 3 over Utep** - Home tm is 2-0 SU/ATS in CUSA mts. LY UTEP snapped a 7 gm series losing streak (but haven't ply'd from 1981-'12) w/ a 35-17 (-6) win. Miners had a 438-201 yd & 18-13 FD edge. North Texas is 3-2 SU/4-1 ATS in home finales. NT is coming off a blowout loss at MT, 41-7 (+23'). NT was outgd' 494-324 & outFD'd 30-18. The Miners may have caught LT looking ahead to their big gm vs SM & almost pulled the upset in a 17-15 (+25) home loss. UTEP was +87 yds & +9 FD's & had multiple chances to take the lead in the 4Q but couldn't capitalize incl missing a 32 yd fg late in the 4Q. The UTEP D held QB Driskel to a ssn low 188 pass yds & held LT to a ssn low 307 tt yds. NT is 8-3 ATS under int HC Canales, while UTEP is 4-8-2 ATS overall.

**MISSISSIPPI ST by 3 over Mississippi** - Egg Bowl. Home tm is 10-1 SU incl 4 str wins/covers. LY #18 Ole Miss pulled the outright upset over #4 MSU 31-17 (+3) w/ a 532-445 yd edge (-6 FD). MSU is coming off a shootout win at Arkansas, 51-50 (+5). The Bulldogs scored the go ahead td late in the 4Q & blocked the GW fg attempt. QB Prescott had car highs in pass yds (508) & tds (5 pass, 2 rush). MSU held 631-479 yd & 32-24 FD edges but were -3 TO's. Ole Miss is coming off a home win over LSU, 38-17 (-7). Ole Miss never trailed & actually led 24-0 in the 1H. Despite the lopsided score, Ole Miss had a ssn low in yds (432) & was -76 yds for the gm. WR Treadwell became the 1st SEC receiver to catch a td pass in 6 str gms s/'08 (UF's Harvin). The Rebels held RB Fournette to 108 yds (4.3 ypc). MSU is +76 ypg on the ssn & +120 ypg at home while Ole Miss is +132 ypg on the ssn & +6 ypg on the road. Against 5 common foes (Bama, A&M, Aub, Ark, LSU), Ole Miss is 4-1 SU/ATS, +11 ppg & +50 ypg while MSU is 2-3 SU/3-2 ATS, -6 ppg & +7 ypg. Bulldogs are 6-1 SU/ATS in home finales. UM HC Freeze is 41-20-1 ATS overall, but MSU is 6-3 as a conf HD.

**STANFORD by 6 over Notre Dame** - Series played every ssn s/'97. Home tm has won 4 str (2 str ATS) w/ the L3Y avg MOV just 4 ppg. LY #9 ND won 17-14 (+3) over #14 SU scoring a td on 4D w/1:01 left. ND did have a 370-205 yd & 21-14 FD edge. A win for the Irish will go a long way towards their playoff hopes. ND won u/g in LW's 19-16 (-15) win vs BC which was played at Fenway in Boston. The score was misleading however, as the Irish led 19-3 in the 4Q & BC scored 2 tds. ND outgd' BC 447-302. ND committed 5 TO's but BC's lackluster offense was not able to convert them into any pts. SU clinched the P12 North Title with a 35-22 (-9) win LW vs Cal. The Cardinals were held to ssn lows w/356 yds & 96 pass yds but Cal settled for 3 fg's in the RZ. RB McCaffrey made big contributions on offense (29-192) & ST's (92 yd KR td). ND is +109 ypg on the ssn & +108 ypg on the road. SU is +77 ypg on the ssn & +113 ypg at home. SU is 5-1 SU in home finales but has dropped 3 str ATS. ND is 8-4 ATS overall.

**SAN DIEGO ST by 13 over Nevada** - The Aztecs are 4-1 SU/3-1 ATS. LY Nevada beat SDSt for the 1st time s/'46 30-14 (-3) but only had a 338-324 yd edge (FD 17-17) & trailed 14-10 at HT (UN handcufted in 2H w/just 66 tt yds). SDSt is 7-0 in MW play for the 1st time in schl history after their 52-14 (-16) win at UNLV. The Aztecs jumped out to a 31-0 HT lead & held UNLV to a ssn low in rush yds (80). SDSt has outscored MW foes 258-76 on the ssn! UN blew a 20 pt lead LW in a 31-27 (+15) loss at Utah St. UN scored on their 1st poss of the 2H to take a 27-7 lead but their L/7 poss resulted in just 36 yds & a FR td. The Wolfpack were held to ssn lows in yds (264) & pass yds (55). SDSt is +131 ypg at home on the ssn while UN is -39 ypg on the road. Against 6 common foes (WY, UNLV, UH, FSU, SJST, UTSt) the Aztecs are 6-0 SU/ATS, +26 ppg & +209 ypg while UN is 4-2 SU/ATS, +2 ppg & +42 ypg. SDSt has won 5 str home finales (4-1 ATS). SDSt is 7-0 ATS overall & 12-3 ATS at home vs conf foes, but UN is 11-3 ATS away.

**Air Force by 9 over NEW MEXICO** - NM is 2-9 SU but have covered L3Y. Home tm is 3-0 SU. LY's gm was tied 21-21 at HT as NM eventually lost 35-31 (+7). NM has outrushed AF in each of the L/3 mts'g (409-272 avg). AF enters having won 6 of 7 incl 5 falcon str after their 37-30 (+11) road win at Boise last Fri. QB Roberts threw for 279 yds, the most by a Falcon s/'89 (306 by Dee Dowsie)! AF had a ssn high 607 yds & finished +229 yds. NM is coming off a 28-21 (+2) loss to CSU which eliminated them from MW Mountain Div contention & clinched the Title for AF. The Lobos were -159 yds & were outgd' for the 6th str gm. NM had two chances to tie the gm in the 4Q but threw int's to end both poss. NM is -70 ypg on the ssn & -124 ypg in MW play while AF is +157 ypg on the ssn & +175 ypg in MW play. The Lobos are on a 7-2 ATS run in home finales. NM is 10-7 ATS overall, but AF is 12-4-1 ATS overall.

**USC by 6 over UCLA** - In the L/3 mtg's both have come in ranked. UCLA is 3-0 SU/ATS leading at HT by DD's in 2 of the gms. Prior USC had won 12 of 13. LY USC lost 38-20 (+4) being outgd' 461-276 & outFD'd 24-16. This winner of this gm will clinch the P12 South Title. USC is coming off a 48-28 (+4) loss at Oregon LW. With the gm tied in the 2Q, UO scored 24 str pts. The Trojans all'd a ssn high 578 yds & committed 12 pen (-124 yds). This was the 1st time the Trojans have been outgd' (-154 yds) s/wk 3. UCLA LW beat Utah 17-9 (pk). UCLA played bend but don't break D. all'g 5 drives of over 10pl, which only resulted in 3 fg's w/2 TO. QB Rosen has now thrown 218 passes w/o an int, which is a schl rec. The Bruins are +166 ypg on the road this ssn while USC is +104 ypg at home. Against 6 common foes (SU, ASU, Utah, Cal, AU, CU), UCLA is 4-2 SU/3-3 ATS, +3 ppg & -3 ypg while USC is 5-1 SU/3-3 ATS, +8 ppg & +18 ypg. USC is 17-10 as a HF, but UCLA is 6-3 as an AD. UCLA is 1-6 ATS when playing B2B road games.

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## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Arizona over SAN FRANCISCO** - Despite a rough start vs his former squad with 2 early int's, QB Palmer ret'd to form as the gm progressed tossing for 317 and 4 TD's as well as leading a final minute drive to knock off CIN by 3. They now take on a 49ers squad that delivered yet another dismal road performance up in SEA (28-14 FD and 509-306 yd deficits) a wk ago to move their own personal ATS mark to just 4-12. Their previous meeting in '15 still has us feeling all warm and fuzzy inside as ARZ delivered arguably the easiest NFL GOM in Northwest history with a 47-7 victory (-6) behind a dominant ARZ defense that forced 4 SF TO's (2 ret for TD's) while holding them to just 156 tll yds in the process. While the Cardinals do have a revenge matchup on deck against the Rams in STL and the 49ers have won outright as a HD on 3 occasions this ssn, keep in mind that ARZ and their #2 scoring offense (33.6 ppg) have gone 15-6 ATS away from home while also covering 8 of their L/12 meetings against the NFC West. **FORECAST: ARIZONA by 16**

**3★ Houston over New Orleans** - While NO has gone a fairly solid 6-3-1 ATS foll'g their bye wk, there are clearly some major issues facing them on the def side of the ball as they all'd a franchise-worst 130 pts over their past 3 contests incl 47 in their most recent matchup at WAS. Now under new leadership on that side of the ball (DC Ryan fired LW), the Saints head to Houston to take on a Texans team that started their 3rd different QB of the ssn (Yates 16-34-229-2-0) LW while delivering a 3rd straight victory in the process to move to 5-5 and in a 1st place tie with the Colts in the AFC South (all'd just 267 yds to NYJ). The deciding factor on our selection for HOU in this one is their #10 defense (22.8 ppg, 333 ypg) that is clearly still light years ahead of NO who currently rank LAST in ppg (31.5) and ypg (424) all'd. **FORECAST: HOUSTON by 10**

## OTHER SELECTION

**2★ Pittsburgh over SEATTLE** - PIT find themselves in fairly good shape in the AFC playoff picture after their 21 pt win over CLE 2 wks ago behind QB Roethlisberger's 379 yd, 3 TD performance off the bench. They now head to Seattle well-rested following their bye week in search of an NFC West SU/ATS sweep (earlier wins over SF, STL & ARZ) against a Seahawks team that moved back to .500 on the ssn following their 2nd dominating performance over SF in a 4-wk span as RB Rawls posted 255 tll yds and 2 TD for the inj'd Lynch (CS here). While the home of the "12th Man" has been one of the most dominant venues in the NFL the previous 3 ssn (22-2 SU regular ssn record), SEA has been somewhat vulnerable recently with a pair of losses to CAR and ARZ dating back to mid-Oct. **FORECAST: PITTSBURGH by 1**

## OTHER GAMES

### THANKSGIVING DAY:

**Philadelphia by 3 over DETROIT** - PHI was manhandled 45-17 as nearly a TD fav a wk ago at home vs TB (outgained 521-383) thanks in part to 4 TO's incl 3 int's by QB Sanchez who was making his 1st start in the ssn for the inj'd Bradford (CS here). PHI is back on Thanksgiving for a 2nd consec ssn as they went into Dallas a ssn ago and came out with an easy 33-10 win as a 3 pt dog (464-267 yd edge). They now take on a Lions squad that has won 2 straight matchups in their showcase game (34-17 vs CHI) after dropping 10 in a row prior (3-8 ATS run on T-Day). While DET was able to pick up a 2nd straight win a wk ago vs OAK (22-13 FD & 375-214 yd edges), this is clearly a different team than LY's version as they are on a 3-10 ATS run. With a dormant Lions running game that is avg just 71 ypg on the ssn (DEAD LAST in NFL), we expect the Eagles to get back on track and stay in full contention for the NFC East crown with a victory here.

**Carolina by 3 over DALLAS** - The Panthers continued their dominance of the NFL a week ago vs WAS by moving their consec reg ssn win streak to 14 in a row (9-2 ATS run). While QB Newton shined again with 5 TD's, the real story was a CAR D that all'd just 10 FD's and 185 yds along with forcing 5 TO's. They now head to Dallas on a short week to take on a Cowboys squad that finally jumped back into the win column delivering a 3.5★ Top Play LP Winner with Romo back at QB (lost 7 str w/o). Romo (16-3 in L/19 sts) shook off some early rust (2 int) to throw for 227 yds and 2 TD's while their D held MIA scoreless in the 4Q. DAL did find themselves on the wrong side of a blowout last Thanksgiving vs PHI who put up 33 pts and 464 yds in the 23rd pt win. While the Panthers clearly have more wiggle room than the Cowboys in this one with a 2-gm lead atop the NFC standings, a win here for DAL (3-7 ATS run) may be just a little too much to ask for!

**GREEN BAY by 13 over Chicago** - An outstanding performance defending MIN RB Peterson (45 yds on 13 carries, came in avg 118 ypg lifetime vs GB) and a 5-5 FG showing from K Crosby saw GB end their 3-gm losing streak and get back into a 1st place tie atop the NFC North with their 17 pt win over MIN. CHI meanwhile was unable to deliver a 3rd straight win as their 2 pt conv w/24 left fell short in the 17-15 loss at home to the Broncos (CHI 1st tm s/07 to go an entire gm w/o a penalty). CHI now makes a Thanksgiving appearance for a 2nd straight ssn with the hope that this matchup will be better than the first as DET went on a 31-3 run to close out the gm. That may prove to be a difficult feat in this one however as not only have the Packers dominated this series over the past 5 yrs with an 8-1 SU/ATS mark (12 pt avg MOV), but they are also expected to get an extra boost of energy from the Lambeau faithful with the jersey retirement ceremony of legendary QB Brett Favre.

### SUNDAY:

**Minnesota by 4 over ATLANTA** - The Vikings were one of the hottest teams in the NFL heading into LW's contest against the Packers as they were carrying a 5-gm winning streak along with an amazing 8 consec covers. Unfortunately streaks are meant to be broken and that's just what happened with GB coming out victorious for the 1st time in 4 wks with the 30-13 win to move into a 1st place tie w/MIN atop the NFC North standings. The Vikings now head to the Georgia Dome to take on a Falcons team that blew a 21-7 lead in the 3Q against a Luck-less Colts squad (375-276 yd deficit) while also losing leading rusher Freeman to a concussion in the process (CS). ATL now finds themselves in quite the skid with losses in 4 of their L/5 (6 straight ATS defeats) after a 5-0 SU start to the yr. The Vikings on the other hand have gone 13-3 ATS vs NDIV foes and will look to continue their solid run off a SU loss as they've now covered 16 of their past 22 in that situation.

**CINCINNATI by 10 over St Louis** - After an 8-0 start to the ssn that included a 7-0-1 ATS mark, the Bengals have now been tripped up in each of the past 2 wks following their last second road loss to ARZ. They now return home with an impressive 11-4-2 ATS record as a HF to take on a Rams team that has coincidentally struggled in their role as an AD (6-14 ATS) which includes their performance LW at BAL as they blew a 13-3 lead in the 4Q thanks in part to 4 TO's incl a crucial fumble late by QB Keenum making his 1st start of the yr for the ineffective Foles (outgained 388-213 for the gm). With the idle Steelers now within reach of the Bengals atop the AFC North trailing by just 2 gms, CIN will need to get their act together here and improve upon their 31-12-4 ATS mark vs NDIV foes to get some much needed breathing room!

**INDIANAPOLIS by 3 over Tampa Bay** - The Bucs have been one of the bigger surprises of the 2015 NFL ssn as they've now covered 5 of their L/6 contests while finally winning SU in consec wks for the 1st time since mid-2013 as they went into Philly and throttled the Eagles 45-17 behind a 5 TD outing from QB Winston (TB 521-383 yd edge). The Colts meanwhile moved to 3-0 on the ssn behind veteran 40-yr old QB Hasselbeck as they erased a 21-7 deficit in the 3Q (4 ATL TO's) to stay tied atop the AFC South standings w/HOU at 5-5. While IND has struggled overall against NDIV foes losing 6 of their L/8 regular ssn matchups, TB has proven to be a road warrior dating back to LY w/a 5-1 ATS mark all'g them to stay within reach here.

**WASHINGTON by 3 over NY Giants** - The Giants return from their bye week sitting atop the NFC East standings at 5-5. The Redskins meanwhile find themselves just a game out following their loss last weekend at undefeated CAR, a game in which they were outFD'd (27-10) and outgained (366-185) by huge margins in the 28 pt loss. In the previous Wk 3 meeting between these 2 squads on TNF, the Giants were able to jump out to a 25-6 lead early in the 4Q prior to the Redskins (-3 TO deficit) scoring a pair of TD's in the final 4:00 to pull within 11 at the end (WAS 393-363 yd edge). While the Redskins have now dropped all 5 of their road

contests this ssn being outscored (32-17) and outgained (417-265) by substantial margins, the same cannot be said inside of their own home venue where they've dominated with a 4-1 mark that includes solid scoring (27-18) and yardage (404-324) advantages of their own (NYG outgained 435-316 away from home in '15).

**Oakland by 3 over TENNESSEE** - The Titans went into JAX last Thur and came out with their 8th loss in their past 9 as they were unable to hold onto a 13-9 4Q lead. They now return home where they've lost 10 straight gms overall (4-14-2 ATS) to take on OAK tm that has dropped a ssn-high 3 consec gms foll'g LW's 5 pt loss in DET, a game in which they were held to a ssn-low 214 tll yds (avg 374 ypg coming in). While OAK entered '15 serving as an AF just once in the past 9 yrs, this will mark their 3rd time in that position TY which should bode well against a Titans squad that's clearly struggling in their role as a dog with just a 7-17-2 ATS record.

**KANSAS CITY by 7 over Buffalo** - Major Wild Card implications in this one as the 5-4 Bills head to Arrowhead following their MNF tilt with NE to take on a red hot Chiefs squad that has catapulted themselves back into playoff contention following their 4th consec SU/ATS win LW on the road against the Chargers, a game where their defense held SD to just 201 yds during the 30 pt victory. KC now returns home where they haven't been since Oct 25th (2 road gms, trip to London, bye week) giving them an extra spark to get by in this one against a BUF team that is not only on short rest, but on the road for a 3rd consec week as well.

**Miami by 1 over NY JETS** - After a 4-1 start to begin the ssn, the Jets have now dropped 4 of their past 5 contests incl a 7 pt loss LW at HOU, a game in which they were able to muster just 267 yds of offense. Up next for NY is a Dolphins squad that's had a mixed bag of results under interim HC Campbell who ironically took over following MIA's last meeting with the Jets in London (27-14 loss, outgained by 199 yds). The Dolphins were unable to get it done a wk ago at home against the Cowboys as QB Romo returned to help deliver a 10 pt win with substantial FD (22-10) and yardage (386-210) edges. While MIA has been a solid 32-18-1 ATS as an AD, the even more impressive trend has been their success against the Jets on the road as they've now been victorious in 6 of their previous 7 trips including wins in each of the past 3 yrs (23-8 avg MOV). With revenge on their mind following their defeat against the pond earlier in the ssn, the Dolphins escape with yet another victory here against a Jets squad that now appears to be on the outside looking in for a potential playoff spot.

**JACKSONVILLE by 7 over San Diego** - The Jaguars have now delivered victories in 3 of their past 4 contests following LW's come-from-behind 4Q win against the Titans (B2B wins for 1st time since Dec '13). They now take on a Chargers squad that's suffered 6 straight defeats following their 30 pt home loss to the Chiefs, a game in which they couldn't get anything going offensively being held to just 201 yds. For the 4th time TY, SD is set to play at 10am PST, a situation they've clearly struggled in (0-3 SU, 1-2 ATS). Meanwhile, JAX now has some key momentum as they sit just a game back in the AFC South standings at 4-6 on the year.

**New England at DENVER - SNF** - The Broncos were able to escape with a 17-15 victory a week ago against the Bears (CHI 2pt NG w/24 left) behind QB Osweiler who hit 20-27 for 250 yds and 2 TD's in his 1st career start for the inj'd Manning (DEN 170 rush yds after combining for just 141 the previous 2 wks). They now host a Patriots squad on an 11-5-1 ATS run vs NDIV foes (NE could also be one of just two remaining tms undefeated on the year, MNF vs BUF). The Broncos have been outscored by a 37-24 clip the past 4 ssn in SU/ATS losses to NE including LY (43-21 defeat as a 3 pt fav) and in '11 when the Pats easily won our NFL GOY in Denver (41-23)! The Broncos are however on an 18-9 ATS at home and get the Patriots traveling to the altitude on a short wk. Call your VIP Debit Card on game day to get the winner of this Premium Marquee Matchup!

**Baltimore vs CLEVELAND - MNF** - A pair of struggling DIV rivals square off in this one as despite finally coming out on the right side of a close contest a wk ago against STL (GW 47-yd FG w/03 left), the Ravens were dealt some terrible inj'd news during the gm with ssn-ending losses to both QB Flacco and RB Forsett. The Browns meanwhile have had their own share of problems as they've now dropped 5 straight (0-4-1 ATS) with their last victory coming against this very same Ravens squad back in Oct, a game in which CLE outgained BAL by a 505-377 margin and got the win in OT. QB Manziel will be the signal caller for the Browns this time around however following a solid pre-bye week outing against PIT where he threw for 372 yds despite being sk'd on 6 occasions. If the Browns are going to get the ssn sweep here, they'll have to re-establish a meager running gm that's avg just 76 ypg (#31 NFL) on the yr against a wounded Ravens team that's on a 2-10-1 ATS run.
