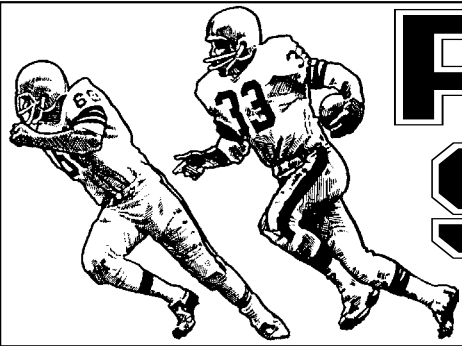

4★ Georgia over TENNESSEE - UGA has won the L/5 meetings in this series SU, but UT is 7-2 ATS. Both of these tms are coming off tough losses. LW UGA was hyped up as a Fav vs Bama (-1) but failed to deliver, losing 38-10. UGA's only td was on an 83 yd Nick Chubb run late 3Q. Bama ran out to a 24-3 lead at HT and then scored to open the 2H. Bama only had 379-299 yd & 14-12 FD edges. Tennessee jumped on Arkansas early 14-0 but the Hogs power run gm wore UT's D out. UT was outg'd 494-365, and most of the damage was done on the ground (275, 5.5). UA almost let UT back in the gm after failing on a fake fg. UT was SOD at their own 43 to end the gm. LY UGA won 35-32 (-17). UGA is 3-0 ATS off a loss and will be looking to get the bitter taste out of their mouths following last weeks showing and need a win to regain control of the SEC East standings.

FORECAST: GEORGIA BY 10

3★ Duke over ARMY - These two last met in '10 and Army rolled to a 35-7 lead winning 35-21 (+6) on the road. Things have changed since that meeting as Duke is vastly improved. The Blue Devils did just face GT's triple option 2 wks ago and is 7-2 SU in this series. The Blue Devils are off a physical 9-7 (-4) home win over BC, but were held to just 228 ttl yds. It was their 1st win without a td s/78 and are 4-1 in B2B sns for the 1st time s/62-'65! Army nearly pulled the upset at PSU LW, losing 20-14 (+24) as they fumbled 7X, losing 3. The Black Knights actually had 293-264 yd & 17-12 FD edges. Driving for the go-ahead score, QB Schurr was sacked on 4&5 from the PSU 43 with under 2:00 to play. Duke is all'g just 123 (3.0) rush ypg and only all'd 173 (2.9) vs the GT option. This is Duke HC Cutcliffe's 8th yr and they've been an AF a ttl of 5X going 3-1-1 ATS. The Blue Devils have a bye on deck & Army, while on a 6-1 ATS run overall, is just 12-17 as a HD. Duke is on a 22-9-1 ATS run and is 26-17 ATS off a SU win. Last weeks results give us some value here and Duke is the superior team while Army has struggled for the most part this ssn.

FORECAST: DUKE BY 21

3★ San Diego St over HAWAII - SDSSt is 7-1-1 ATS vs UH and 3-0 SU/ATS since UH joined the MW. UH is coming off a rough loss at Boise, 55-0 (+25). We went a perfect 3-0 on our Saturday LPS Totals incl the UNDER in the Hawaii/Boise game as our 3.5★. UH was outg'd 554-170 and outFD'd 29-12. That was already the 3rd time that UH was shutout this ssn! SDSSt beat Fresno St 21-7 LW (-7). SDSSt outg'd FSt 409-89 and outFD'd their 19-6! LY the Aztecs beat UH 20-10 (-7). SDSSt led 17-10 into the 4Q and outg'd UH 457-264. UH's L/3 poss ended in TO's. SDSSt looks to have another strong performance on D against UH which avg's 15 ppg and 297 ypg. SDSSt is 6-0 as an AF and 12-7 under Long as a Fav vs MW tms. UH is just 7-16 as a Dog vs MW tms. Being on the West coast, the Aztecs won't mind the travel to the islands.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Wisconsin over NEBRASKA - You know it wouldn't be a special 5★ weekend without including Wisconsin in the mix, who have brought us a fair share of big play winners over the years. Both teams are coming off being outright upset. UW is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS in recent mtgs including the '12 B10 champ gm when the Badgers won 70-31! LW UW lost as a HF vs Iowa 10-6 but actually had 320-221 yd & 21-14 FD edges. The Badgers had 4 TO's including a fmb! on the Iowa 1 when QB Stave tripped and lost the ball. UW shut Iowa out in the 2H. The Badgers struggled to run the ball, and will look to get their rushing attack going this week, but NU does have a solid rush D. NU blew a 13-0 4Q lead to lose 14-13 to Illinois. The Huskers time management was mind boggling as they could have run the clock out but threw two inc passes to give Illinois more time. NU all'd the GW td with 0:10 left. The Huskers were outg'd 382-292 & outFD'd 17-12. UH was 0-4 in the RZ in the 1H and NU was fortunate to have a lead into the 4Q. This will be a matchup of strengths as both tms stop the run well. UW is all'g 94 rush ypg (3.1 ypc) while NU is all'g 85 ypg (3.1 ypc). NU is just 1-6 ATS being upset twice hosting B10 foes. This is UW's first true AG and the first time leaving Madison in a month, but the Badgers have a history of showing up big in October conference games, while Nebraska keeps finding new ways to lose games under 1st yr HC Riley.

2★ Lsu over SOUTH CAROLINA - LSU has dominated this series, 17-2-1 SU and 5-1-1 ATS at SC, but the last meeting was in 2012. The Tigers are coming off a lackluster win over EMU 44-22 (-45) as they've been no doubt itching to get back into SEC play. LSU led 20-14 and 30-22 in the 4Q. RB Fournette became the 1st player in SEC history to rush for 200+ in 3 str gms! SC is struggling and lost at another struggling SEC team in Missouri 24-10 (-3) LW. The final stats were close, but the Gamecocks couldn't overcome 3 TO's along with more QB concerns. The Pokes are undefeated at 5-0, but got some help from the officials in their 36-34 (-7) nail biter over K-St. PK Grogan hit a 37 yd fg w/32 left as OSU came back from a 28-13 late 1H deficit. That was already the 2nd GW fg that Grogan has hit TY. The Pokes did have a 490-351 yd edge and QB Rudolph hit 34-55-437-3-1, so the score was a bit misleading. QB Mayfield threw for 320 yds & 3 td's as OU led 24-7 at HT. UT enters having lost 3 str, the latest an embarrassing 50-7 (+14) loss at TCU. The Hoosiers had a chance to send the gm into OT but their 4&g pass was incomplete in the EZ on the final pl of the gm. OSU had a 517-402 yd edge but were outFD'd 21-13 & were -3 in TO's. RB Elliot put his name back into the minds of Heisman voters as he rushed for 274 yds (243 in the 2H!) & became the only player in the L10Y w/3 runs of 50+ td's in 1 half! MD is off a 28-0 (+14) home loss to Michigan as they were held to just 105 ttl yds & 7 FD's! QB Rowe was limited to just 8-27-47-0-3. This is MD's first trip to Ohio Stadium and they are 1-13 SU vs ranked foes incl 11 str losses by 23 ppg. The Terps are 9-5 as an AD, while the Buckeyes are 0-3 as a HF this year & HC Meyer is just 12-19 as a DD fav.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 13 over Wake Forest - Both teams are in search of their 1st ACC win of the ssn. The home team is 7-4 SU/ATS in this series, while BC is 5-2 SU/ATS. The Eagles are off a 9-7 (+4) loss at Duke. They missed a punt at their own 15 yd line in the 3Q & missed a 45 yd fg in the 4Q. BC used 2 QB's & both struggled w/Flutie being hurt late after a scramble (CS). WF is off a 24-16 (+20) loss to FSU despite 357-329 yd & 27-14 FD edges. The Deacons had a chance to send the gm into OT but threw an int in the EZ from the 'Noles 20 yd line with :21 left to play. Neither of these teams have showed much promise on the offensive side of the ball as both have been defensive oriented, especially BC which has held all 3 of their FBS foes to their ssn lows in tll yds and is #1 in the FBS holding their opponents to 247 yds less than their ssn avg! BC is 8-4 as a HF while HC Addazio is 12-5 ATS vs conf foes and is 18-25 as an AD. However, BC has big road games with Clemson and Lville on deck.

We elevated our 2★ on these pages LW to a 3★ LPS play on Saturday and cashed going against the Bobcats in their 14-12 (-2) win at Akron as they were outg'd 319-227 & outFD'd 21-17. Miami is still searching for its 1st FBS win of the ssn after falling 20-14 (+10) at Kent LW. The Redhawks were down 20-0 before scoring 2 late 4Q td's and ended the gm w/416-350 yd & 24-13 FD edges but were -3 in TO's. LY OU got a 38 yd pass w/:02 left to set up a 28 yd fg as time exp to pull out a 24-21 road win (-3). The Bobcats are just 7-17-1 vs conf foes incl 3-10 as a conf fav. The Redhawks have lost 20 str gms on the road (3rd str AG here), but are 6-3 as an AD.

TOLEDO by 21 over Kent St - Toledo has won 10 str at home in this MAC rivalry. The last time KSU won here was in '77! The Rockets have won 9 of the L/11 SU. Toledo is undefeated on the season and is coming off a 24-10 (-5) win at Ball St where they had a 444-262 yd edge and had a 24-0 lead before giving up a fg on the final pl of the 3Q. RB Hunt remained out (hamstring) but Terry Swanson rushed for 139 (5.8) as the Rockets had 280 (5.8) rush yds. KSU is all g just 83 (2.2) rush ypg on the ssn. They're off a 20-14 (-10) homecoming win over Miami as they all'd all 14 pts and 179 pass yds in the 4Q, which was their 1st FBS win of the yr. Toledo is just 2-5-1 as a conf fav. KSU hasn't won 2 str gms s/13 but the L/time UT came into a gm ranked they lost outright at home in '12 (#23 vs Ball St 34-27 -6).

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 10 over Ball St - NIU has won 13 of 16 incl 6 str by an avg of 16 ppg and is on a 12-6 ATS run (incl 4-1) in this series and the visitor is on a 5-1 ATS run. Well it happened again. The Huskies had lost just 2 reg ssn gms in MAC play the L4Y, with both coming at the hands of CMU. Make that 3, again to CMU after their 29-19 (-2) loss on the road. NIU led 10-3 at HT and had 316-265 yd & 17-14 FD edges but were done in by -3 TO's. The Huskies have now uncharacteristically lost 3 str. BSU also enters off a loss, this at the hands of Toledo, 24-10 (+5). Appalachian St by 17 over GEORGIA ST - These schls met for the 1st time LY with App St rolling to a 44-0 (-13) shutout win, their first ever home win vs an FBS foe as an FBS member. The Mountaineers enter off a 31-13 (-25) home win over Wyoming as RB Cox scored on a 59 yd run on their 1st play from scrimmage and led 31-7 until all g a gbg td w/:44 remaining. App St was outg'd 373-314 & outFD'd 18-14 as they benefitted from +2 TO's. They entered the gm all g just 73 (2.3) rush ypg but all'd 218 (4.3). GST meanwhile, is off a 41-33 (-2) home loss to FCS Liberty, getting outg'd 502-405 incl 263-11 on the ground & outFD'd 24-14. GST is all g 206 (4.6) rush ypg, while App St is avg 286 (6.0) rush ypg. The Panthers are now 1-19 SU at home & are 0-4 as a conf HD. This will be just App St's 2nd gm as an AF, but they did roll to a 49-0 (-7) win at ODU 2 wks ago.

PITTSBURGH by 14 over Virginia - The HT is a perfect 4-0 SU/ATS in this series with LY's gm being the closest as the previous 3 were decided by 11, 30 and 25 pts. Pitt enters off a 17-13 (+3) win at VT, giving HC Narduzzi his 1st ACC victory. The Panthers limited VT to just 100 tll yds incl 9 rush to go along with 7 sks & 3 ints! Virginia enters fresh off a bye following their embarrassing 56-14 (+2) home loss the previous Friday to Boise when they were outg'd 447-273, outFD'd 19-10 & were -5 in TO's. The 'Hoos lone win this yr came by just 6 pts vs FCS William & Mary and they are avg 350 tll ypg incl just 94 (3.0) rush ypg, while Pitt is all g just 244 tll ypg incl just 71 (2.5) rush ypg and are holding their opponents to 232 yds less than their ssn avg. The Panthers are just 7-10 ATS vs conf foes while UVA HC London is 5-2-1 ATS off a bye.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 13 over Central Michigan - The "Battle for the Cannon" will be at stake as this will be the 86th all-time meeting in a rivalry that started in 1907! CM is 6-3 SU/5-3-1 ATS in this series and the visitor is 3-0 SU/ATS. The Chips pulled off another outright upset over NIU LW, this time 29-19 (+2) despite being held to just 265 yds & 14 FD's as they capitalized by being +4 in TO's. WM enters fresh off a bye after their 38-12 (+32) loss at defending Nat'l Champion Ohio State. LY CM jumped out to a 14-0 lead after 1Q & went on to win 32-20 (E). CM is on a 6-0 ATS run, but are just 1-5 ATS as a dog in this rivalry. WM is 7-1 ATS vs conf foes and are 3-1 ATS off a bye.

ALABAMA by 18 over Arkansas - Bama has won 8 in a row SU (5-3 ATS) in this SEC rivalry. Bama was a rare dog LW for the 1st time s/09 and obviously felt disrespected. The Tide went on the road and embarrassed UGA 38-10 (+1), dominating in all 3 phases. Bama led 24-3 at HT & held the Bulldogs to just 299 tll yds 12 FD's while forcing 4 TO's. Arkansas snapped their 3 gm losing streak with a come-from-behind 24-20 (+6) win in Knoxville vs Tenn. Down 14-0 early, the Hogs rebounded to tie the gm at HT and had a 494-365 yd edge incl 274-133 on the ground as RB's Collins & Williams each had 100 yd gms. Entering LY's gm Bama had B2B 52-0 series wins but travelled to Ark the week after getting upset by Ole Miss. The Tide was outg'd 335-227, but Ark fumbled into the EZ for a TB at the end so the Tide were very fortunate to escape with a 14-13 (-9) win. The last time they had a narrow win at Ark was in '10 and the next year at home they bounced back with a 38-14 win (-11). Bama is avg 444 tll ypg while all g just 273 ypg incl just 84 (2.7) rush ypg and are avg 135 more ypg than their opponents are all g while holding their opponents to 188 yds less than their ssn avg. The Hogs are avg 476 tll ypg incl 204 (5.1) rush and are holding their opponents to 114 ypg less than their ssn avg. Bama is on an 0-6 ATS run as a HF and has A&M on deck, but Ark is just 5-9-1 as an AD and this is the Hog's 3rd str AG.

AIR FORCE by 21 over Wyoming - This is the 54th meeting in the Front Range Rivalry, AF has won 6 of the L/9 SU, but have dropped B2B, while Wyoming is on a 12-6 ATS run incl 6-0. The visitor is 7-3 SU & there have been 5 outright upsets the L10Y incl LY. AF enters off a 33-11 (+6) loss at rival Navy. The Falcons actually had the FD edge and were only outg'd 387-277 but were done in by -4 in TO's all in Navy territory and were SOD at the 1! Wyoming remains winless on the ssn after their 31-13 (+25) loss at App St. The Pokes did have 373-314 yd & 18-14 FD edges but were -2 in TO's. Wyoming is all g 216 (5.6) rush ypg and that even includes giving up just 75 to Wazzu, while AF and their triple option offense is avg 326 (5.5) rush ypg and have run for 200+ yds in every gm this ssn. AF led the entire gm LY only to lose 17-13 (-2) after giving up a 3 yd td pass w/:58 left. The Falcons are just 5-14 ATS off a SU loss, 7-15 as a conf fav & 0-5 ATS after rival Navy, while Wyoming is 22-10 as an AD.

BOWLING GREEN by 14 over UMass - BG has won all 3 gms (1-2 ATS) but after winning the F/2 by 21 ppg, needed a 4Q comeback LY. BG is off a 28-22 (-8) win at Buffalo as they led 21-6 at HT and withstood a Bull rally. The Falcons had a 536-500 yd edge but were outFD'd 34-25. With the win BG became one of just 3 FBS tms to have 3 wins on the road already this ssn (Temple & Memphis). UMass is off a 24-14 (-3) home win over FIU as WR Sharpe set a schl record with 15 rec's (159 yds). The Minutemen dominated as they had 495-188 yd & 29-13 FD edges. The Falcons are just 1-4 as a HF incl 2-7 ATS in their conf home opener, while UMass is just 7-11 as an AD, but are 3-0 ATS in their conf opener.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 31 over Troy - Troy is 2-20 all time vs SEC schls with the avg score 41-19 and are 1-3 in Starkville (win in '01). The Trojans are off a 24-18 (-7) home loss to South Alabama as they were outg'd 365-265 & outFD'd 21-18. MSU is off a 30-17 (+4) loss at A&M as they were down 24-10 at HT and outg'd 516-406 for the gm. The Bulldogs are avg 440 ypg with 3 gms already vs SEC foes while the Trojans are all g 426 ypg on the road. Troy is also all g 218 (4.3) rush ypg so look for MSU QB Prescott to pad his stats not only thru the air, but also on the ground as he is one of the elite dual threat QB's in the nation. MSU is on an 18-12-1 ATS run and HC Mullen is 17-10 as a HF.

MISSISSIPPI by 49 over New Mexico St - First meeting. The Aggies are 0-17 all-time vs SEC opponents losing by an avg 50-12. Ole Miss was upset on the road vs Florida LW, losing 38-10 (-6) despite being outg'd just 355-328 and holding a 23-18 FD edge as they were done in by -4 TO's. NMSt is still in search of their first win of the ssn after their 38-29 (+12) loss to rival NM. RB Rose III had 260 rush yds incl 251 in the F/3Q as the Aggies led 29-14 mid 3Q, but they couldn't hold onto the lead as they all'd the final 24 pts and were outg'd 446-416. Ole Miss will look to take out their frustration over no longer being undefeated and will be able to name the score here. HC Freeze is 12-4-1 ATS vs non-conf foes and 10-6 as a HF, while the Aggies are just 6-11-2 vs non-conf foes.

BYU by 14 over East Carolina - This is the 1st all-time meeting between these schools. As a matter of fact, EC has not played in a state farther west than Texas since the '07 Hawaii Bowl and its their longest reg ssn road trip since a 35-0 loss at Washington in '93! BYU has had an extra day to prepare following their 30-13 (-14) win over UConn last Friday as QB Mangum rebounded from his poor performance the week prior to hit 35-53-365-2-2 as the Cougars had 539-230 yd & 31-14 FD edges. Baylor enters off their dominating 63-35 (-17) blowout win over TT as QB Russell had 367 tll yds & 5 td's. RB Linwood rushed for a car high 221 yds & 2 td's as the Bears had a 680-636 yd edge and were +3 in TO's. KU is still in search of their first win of the ssn and enter this gm off a 38-13 (+17) loss at ISU as we cashed a 2★ on these pages going against them. The Jayhawks trailed 24-0 late 3Q and were outg'd 512-288 & outFD'd 24-15. Kansas is all g 535 ypg and is also all g 128 ypg more than what their opponents are avg on the ssn, while BU is avg 745 ypg and is avg 228 ypg more than what their opponents are all g on the ssn. BU is just 3-8-1 as an AF, but are 16-7-1 as a DD fav. KU might be without its #1 & #2 QB's (CS) leaving the duties to a Fr.

FLORIDA ATLANTIC by 2 over Rice - Rice won the only mtg in '13, 18-14 (-14). Rice was handily beaten LW vs WKU 49-10 (+7). Rice was outg'd 504-322 and outFD'd 24-15. UO outg'd CU 537-308 & outFD'd them 27-18. WSU lost to Cal LW 34-28 (+17). WSU led 21-7 in the 2Q and 28-20 in the 3Q but gave up 2 TD's in a 1:39 span and WSU could not find the EZ in the 4Q. ND showed a lot of heart in their 24-22 loss at Clemson LW (+2), cashing a 3★ on these pages. ND trailed 21-3 and 24-9 in the 4Q but scored td's with 9:03 and 0:07 left. ND could have tied the gm but their last 2 pt conv try failed. Now ND must bounce back vs Navy's triple option. Navy is off a rivalry gm vs Air Force. Navy had a 387-277 yd edge and won 33-11. The gm could have been much closer as AF had 4 TO's (all in Navy territory) in the 1H and was SOD at the Navy 1. LY ND won 49-39 (-14). ND is 8-1 (5-3 ATS) vs triple option tms under HC Kelly. ND is in a large sandwich gm off of Clemson with USC on deck.

ARIZONA STATE by 6 over Colorado - ASU is 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS in this series, winning by 27 ppg. CU was competitive vs Oregon LW as the gm was tied at 17 at HT. The lack of depth caught up to them in the 2H and UO blew it open to win 41-24 (+7). ASU bounced back in a big way LW vs UCLA to win 38-23 (+12). ASU had 465-342 yd & 25-17 FD edges. UF held a 285-128 yd edge at HT. UF outg'd UM 355-328 but were outFD'd 23-18. UF forced 4 TO's which they converted into 20 pts. Lock filled in nicely for sspn QB Mauk (CS) in a 24-10 win over SC (-3). MU only had 299-298 yd & 18-17 FD edges, but forced 3 TO's. DE Brady had a huge gm with 2 sks on 3rd Downs and an INT. TT ran out of steam LW at Baylor (+17) losing 63-35. TT was only outg'd 680-636 but was -3 TO's which BU converted into 14 pts. TT won in '14 34-31 (+1). SA won outright LW (+7) and outg'd Troy 365-265. ASt (-10) had an all around effort LY, beating SA 45-10 (400-201 yd edge). It was 45-3 before SA gained 59% of their yards (120) and their only td of the game. ASt will look to expose SA's poor run D which has all'd 204 ypg (5.1 ypc). ASt is 4-10 on the road, 5-9 ATS. The HT is 13-4 ATS. ASt has failed to cover 5 str AG's being outright upset 2k's in SB play. The Rams meanwhile went into ARZ and handed the Cardinals their 1st loss of the ssn as they forced 3 TO's and held on late for a 2 pt win despite being outFD'd (26-13) and outgained (447-328) by substantial margins. STL is now in their 3rd RG in 4 wks and showed us earlier in the ssn how they handle big wins (24-10 loss at WAS as 3 pt fav following ssn-opening win over SEA) while the Packers (8-1-1 ATS as a HF) have now won an NFL-best 11 consec home games (incl playoffs) behind QB Rodgers and his 486 pass att's w/o an int at Lambeau (43 TD passes in that span)

FORECAST: GREEN BAY by 16

3★ CINCINNATI over Seattle - CIN has posted some pretty impressive ATS marks over the past few ssn at home with a 15-3-1 record including our Weekly 3.5★ LP Top Play Winner over KC, a game in which their defense held the Chiefs to a few FG's early on while RB's Bernard and Hill combined for 102 rush yds and 4 TD's. They now take on a Seahawks tm that heads out East on a short wk (MNF vs DET) with an 0-2 ATS record away from home so far in '15. While the return of S Chancellor has the SEA defense back to their expected high level, the main culprit for their struggles thus far has been an OL that has surrendered 12 sks thru 3 games (QB Wilson struggling with just a 4-2 ratio). While there is no line as of presstime, it is worth noting that this undefeated Bengals team has gone an amazing 21-4-1 as a dog of 3 or less if the situation occurs. They have trailed for just 1:58 all ssn long and are clearly a contender in the AFC. **FORECAST: CINCINNATI by 6**

OTHER SELECTION

2★ Arizona over DETROIT - After dominating their 1st 3 opponents by a 126-49 margin, the Cardinals ran into some TO (3-0 deficit) & RZ issues against the Rams as they had to settle for 5 FG's (21, 27, 42, 38 & 29) in their 2 pt loss (outgained STL 447-328). The Lions meanwhile are more than likely off to an 0-4 start (at SEA on MNF) following their 3rd road contest over the 1st month of the ssn. The biggest concern so far for DET has been a rushing offense that is dead last in the NFL at just 45 ypg. With the Lions now carrying just a 2-9 ATS mark as a dog and ARZ continuing to roll on the road (12-5 ATS) and as an overall favorite (13-4-1), there's no question where we're leaning as Arians is a solid 7-2 ATS off a SU loss. **FORECAST: ARIZONA by 10**

OTHER GAMES

Indianapolis at HOUSTON - TNF - The Colts are back to .500 on the ssn as QB Hasselbeck made his 1st start since Nov of '12 for an inj'd Luck (CS for this one) and guided a GW 27 yd FG in OT for the victory despite a 421-326 yd deficit (IND outgained in each game TY by 55 ypg). The Texans meanwhile struggled mightily in their trip to undefeated ATL as they trailed 42-0 entering the 4Q behind a struggling QB Mallett. IND has delivered against the AFC South with 15 consec SU wins (IND 11-2-2 vs DIV foes) although it is worth noting that the Texans are a completely different animal on the offensive side of the ball when Arian Foster (1,200+ rush yds in 4 of L/5 yrs) is in the lineup (should be a full-go here after just 8 rush att LW in 1st game back from inj). **We'll have one of our Red-Hot Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk (NFL marquee are 16-4, 80% on the ssn!).**

TAMPA BAY by 1 over Jacksonville - Rough spot for both tms heading into this matchup as neither squad has found success in their respective away and home situations. JAX is in the midst of a 3-game road trip (11 straight road losses overall) although they did nearly pull out the win LW in IND against a Colts squad missing QB Luck (JAX outgained IND 431-326 in 3 pt OT loss). The Bucs meanwhile have now dropped 11 consec home contests following LW's 37-23 defeat to CAR, a game in which the Panthers delivered a 3★ LP Winner after forcing 5 Buc TO's incl 4 int's from QB Winston (TB had a big 411-244 yd edge). While we'd prefer to play against both teams in this spot, we'll take JAX and the points as a FG may be too much for the Bucs to cover as they are just 3-7 ATS before a bye while posting a poor 4-14-1 mark as a NDiv HF including a 42-14 (-3) defeat by TEN in the opener.

Buffalo by 5 over TENNESSEE - Bad memories for the Bills fanbase (Music City Miracle) as BUF heads to Nashville to take on a rested Titans team off a bye. Following their domination a wk earlier of MIA, the Bills came out flat at home against the Giants as their offense posted just 2 FD's and 77 yds on their 1st 9 possessions in the 24-10 defeat (17 Bills penalties). Despite their 1-2 mark the Titans have to feel pretty good as they've outgained each of their 1st 3 opponents by 68 ypg while getting some consistent play out of rookie QB Mariota who is avg 278 ypg (64%) with an 8-2 ratio. BUF on the other hand has exchanged good performances (IND/MIA) with bad performances (NE/NYG) and if you go with that trend, this will be their week to shine against a TEN squad that is just 2-12 ATS off a SU loss the past 2 ssn.

BALTIMORE by 11 over Cleveland - Despite a substantial 356-263 yardage edge against the Steelers, the Ravens were fortunate (two missed FG's in 4Q by PIT) to escape Heinz Field with their 1st victory of '15, a 23-20 OT win. BAL now enters this home matchup with extra rest (TNF) against a Browns team fresh out of their West Coast battle with SD, a game in which CLE nearly pulled the outright upset all g SD 2 chances to hit the GW FG as time expired (CLE's 432 ttl yds against the Chargers was 115 over their ssn avg). While BAL's overall recent history against their DIV has been less than stellar (6-13-1 ATS), they have been victorious in 12 of their L/13 meetings against CLE which bodes well for them delivering in this one as they try to climb back into the AFC North race.

ATLANTA by 13 over Washington - Following their final minute come-from-behind victory over PHI a wk ago (3★ LP Winner on Under 45), WAS has now outgained each of their 1st 4 opp by 96 ypg. ATL meanwhile enters this matchup trying to achieve a NFC East SU/ATS sweep for the 2nd time in 4 ssn. Their previous meetings against PHI, NYG and DAL TY have resulted in a pair of outright upsets as a 2 pt dog and an 11 pt road win against the Cowboys as a 1 pt favorite. New HC Quinn has ATL at 4-0 for just the 4th time in franchise history delivering a Top 4★ Winner in Power Sweep against HOU, a game that they actually led 42-0 heading into the 4Q. Despite playing better than most expected so far in '15, the Redskins are just 9-18 ATS as a dog and may have some issues against a resilient Falcons team that now has a game-breaking RB in Freeman (342 ttl yds, 6 TD's L2W) to go along with one of the more dangerous QB/WR combos in the league today in Ryan and Jones.

KANSAS CITY by 17 over Chicago - Despite substantial FD (23-16) and yardage (371-243) edges the Bears needed a 49-yd FG w/:02 remaining to claim their 1st win of the ssn against a Raiders squad that entered play as an AF for just the 2nd time in the past 10 yrs. The Chiefs have fallen on hard times since their ssn opening win over HOU as they've now blown a late lead at home against DEN, were dominated worse than the final score at GB and then gave up 36 pts and 445 yds in their loss LW in Cincy. Fortunately KC returns home where they went 6-2 a ssn outscoring their opponents by 17 ppg in those victories. This doesn't bode well for a Bears team that has gone 8-18 as a dog while being outscored by nearly 24 ppg in their past 7 road defeats.

PHILADELPHIA by 1 over New Orleans - The Eagles return home following another head-scratching offensive performance in their final minute defeat to WAS as they were outgained for the 3rd consec game and have now seen their defense on the field for 58 minutes longer through 4 gms. The Saints got into the win column a wk ago against a pesky Cowboys squad as QB Brees returned from inj following a 1 game absence to throw for 359 yds and 2 TD's (incl an 80-yarder in OT). While the Eagles have been pretty solid as a HF covering 6 of their L/7, the Saints have the momentum heading to Philly to keep this contest within the spread (covered previous 2 meetings by 18 ppg).
New England by 14 over DALLAS - The Patriots return from their bye following a massive 3-game offensive outburst to start the ssn that has them ranked 1st in the NFL in ypg (446) and scoring (39.7). Despite a late TD pass in the final minutes to force OT, DAL's streak of 10 consec road wins ended following an 80-yd TD pass by the Saints on their 1st drive of the extra period, 26-20. While the Cowboys can go all out in this matchup with a bye on deck (CS of LB Lee who left LW w/a concussion), Belichick and company have feasted on QB's making their 1st career start against them (Weeden 239 ypg, 73%, 1-1 ratio in 2 sts TY). This NE team is beginning to resemble their undefeated '07 squad that began the year at 8-0 ATS before some ridiculous spreads started to appear (-18 avg over L/7 gms that ssn). Until Vegas starts overcompensating again, we'll continue to ride the Patriots.
Denver by 7 over OAKLAND - Despite a few miscues by QB Manning and the DEN offense, the Broncos were able to move to 4-0 on the year following their 3 pt home win over MIN. A late FG (:07 left) by the Bears spoiled a potential 2-game road sweep for the Raiders (ended 11-game road losing streak the wk prior vs CLE) as they entered their contest against CHI as an AF for just 2nd time s/'06. While the Raiders have a bye on deck and do have a new HC in Del Rio that spent the previous 3 ssn as the DC of the Broncos, keep in mind that they've gone just 7-17 as a DIV HD. This doesn't bode well against a DEN squad that has outscored them by 18 ppg in their L/4 trips to "The Black Hole" while going 13-2 ATS vs AFC West opponents.
San Francisco at NY GIANTS - SF's offensive woes continued LW at home against the Packers as they posted just 8 FD's and 196 yds in the 17-3 defeat. The 49ers now head back on the road where they've been dismantled so far in '15 against PIT and ARZ by a 90-25 combined margin (outscored 60-10 in 1H). The Giants are off a solid performance in BUF where their defense was able to hold the Bills to 23 pts and 60 yds under their ssn avg. While the Giants have been a solid 7-2 ATS as a DIV HF, it's still worth noting that their ability to hold onto 4Q leads (at DAL, vs ATL) could give the 49ers an opportunity for the backyard in this one as this line may be a little bit on the lofty side after SF's showings the past 3 wks. **Call your VIP Debit Card for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Pittsburgh at SAN DIEGO - MNF - Despite some significant inj's on both their OL and in the secondary, the Chargers were able to get a GW FG as time expired (on the 2nd try) against CLE to move back to 2-2 on the ssn (have outgained 3 of their 4 opponents TY). A pair of missed FG's late in their contest against BAL allowed the Ravens to force OT and eventually get the 3 pt win in a game that the Steelers actually led 20-7 early 3Q (PIT outgained 356-263). QB Vock (157 ttl yds, TD vs BAL) now makes his 1st road start for PIT with a solid 20-11-2 mark as a dog against a Chargers squad that is 18-11-1 as a NDiv HF. **Remember on Monday Nights you can get a \$back+ guarantee!
