4★ BAYLOR over West Virginia - Fourth str ssn playing and just the 4th all-time mtg. Revenge gm for Baylor as LY they were ranked #4 at 6-0 & traveled to WV but lost 41-27 (-7). BU was held to ssn lows in pts (27), FD (22) & yds (318, 263 below ssn avg). LTH BU won 73-42 (-29.5) w/872 ttl yds (all-time high all'd by WV & 73 pts ranked 6th all'd). Baylor is off a blowout win over Kansas 66-7 (-46) who was playing with their 3rd string QB. BU led 52-7 at HT before pulling most of their starters. The Bears 321 pts this ssn are the most ever by any tm through 5 gms! We cashed going against WV as they dropped their gm to OKSt LW 33-26 (-7) in OT as we elevated our 2★ on these pages to a 3★ LPS play on Saturday as part of our 5★ weekend that saw us go 5-1 on our college side selections! WV trail'd 23-9 in the 3Q but came back to force OT. BU avg's 725 ypg of offense while WV is only all'g 342 ypg. BU is 12-3 as a HF, and 17-7-1 as a DD Fav, while WV is 0-2 SU/ATS vs ranked foes, failing to cover by 13 ppg. The Bears are playing at an entirely different level than everyone else so far this ssn and will get their revenge in a major way!

FORECAST: BAYLOR BY 35

3★ FLORIDA STATE over Louisville - UL is 1-8 in Tallahassee but LTH was in '00. FSU trailed 21-0 in the 2Q but had 374 yds in the 2H. FSU won in LY 42-31 (-3). LW FSU won vs rival Miami 29-24 (-7) as we cashed our 2nd 5★ LPS play this yr! FSU led 20-10 at HT & RB Cook put the 'Noles on his back (22-22-2) scoring the game deciding td. In the series, Cook has rushed for more yds vs Miami than any other FSU player! The 'Noles outgd' UM 539-425. UL is fresh off a bye, after a 20-13 road win vs NCSt the wk prior. UL outgd' & outFD'd NCSt 306-228 & 20-11. FSU has outgd' foes by 206 ypg at home while rushing for 264 ypg (5.7 ypc), while the Cardinals all'd 206 (4.5) rush ypg in their losses to Aub, Hou & Clem. FSU is off their big rival gm vs Miami and has to prep for GT's option next wk, but it won't matter this week as RB Cook will look to have another fine rushing day against a UL D that lost a lot of talent to graduation & to the next level. The 'Noles won us a 5★ last week and we'll back them again as a key selection.

FORECAST: FLORIDA STATE BY 17

3★ San Diego St (+) over SAN JOSE ST - SJSt HC. SDSt is 2-0 SU/ATS in MW Play. SJSt has won the L/3 mtgs by 17 ppg. SDSt enters off a win on the islands vs Hawaii 28-14 (+2). The Aztecs outgd' UH 402-251 and forced 3 TO's. This was the 3rd time SDSt held a tm to less than 300 yds of offense. SJSt won a back and forth gm vs UNLV 33-27 (-3) in OT. There was 4 lead changes and UNLV needed a fg to put the game into OT, but the Spartans held on. SDSt is 18-7-1 ATS in MW play while SJSt is on a 4-8 ATS run. This gm features RB Ervin, who has rushed for 874 (6.2) with 11 td's vs SDSt's stingy run D who have all'd a total of just 137 rush yds (1.6 ypc) in the L/3 gms. The Aztecs are avg 180 (4.0) rush ypg and over their L/2 gms have rushed for 305 & 218 yds while SJSt is all'g 228 (5.1) rush ypg on the ssn. SDSt makes the short trip North and will end their 3 gm series losing skid this week.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ WISCONSIN over Purdue - UW HC. The Badgers have dominated the Boilermakers winning 9 str both SU/ATS. LY PU did get within 24-16 but was held to 24 ttl yds its L/5 drives in the 34-16 loss (+17). LTH PU only trailed 14-10 2Q but all'd 27 str in a 41-10 defeat (+22). UW is off an emotional 23-21 (+2) come-from-behind win at Neb, hitting a 46 yd fg w/04 left after missing a 39 yd fg a minute earlier, cashing a 2★ on these pages LW as we went a combined 5-1 on our Star Rated plays! The Badgers all'd Neb to take the lead w/3:38 remaining. UW did have 469-325 yd & 25-13 FD edges, but were uncharacteristic in their approach as QB Stave att'd 50 passes, just the 4th time in sch history a QB has thrown that many & it was their 1st win since the '07 Capital One Bowl they won when throwing more than running. PU remained winless vs FBS foes after their one-sided 41-13 (+3) home loss to Minn LW. The Boilermakers were down just 10-6 at HT but couldn't get anything going in the 2H and were outgd' 408-275 while turning the ball over 4X. PU is 4-2 ATS before a reg ssn bye & UW HC Chryst is on an 11-16 ATS run overall, but that doesn't deter us here as series history highly favors the Badgers and we will back them again.

FORECAST: WISCONSIN BY 28

2★ Alabama over TEXAS A&M - Bama is 4-1 in reg ssn gms but A&M has covered 2 of the L3Y. LY #7 Bama's 59-0 (-13) whipping of #21 A&M was its most lopsided win s/79. LTH the #1 Tide won 49-42 (-8) over #6 A&M but Bama all'd a ssn high 628 yds (next closest in reg ssn was 393). The Tide has now won 3 str gms this yr following their upset loss to Ole Miss as they defeated Arkansas 27-14 (-16). Bama was down 7-3 at HT, but started to wear down the hogs scoring all 24 of their 2H pts in the final 16:39 of the gm. They did have 396-220 yd & 22-9 FD edges and RB Henry had a car high 27 carries and broke the sch record with a td in 11 str gms. A&M is fresh off a bye and beat MSU 30-17 (-4) the week prior as they had a 516-406 yd edge. The Aggies are avg 480 ypg & QB Allen has eclipsed 300 pass yds in each of their past 3 gms. Bama however, is still as dominant as ever on D as they are all'g just 265 ttl ypg & just 51.1% completions. The Tide is also #3 in the FBS all'g 203 ypg less than what their foes are avg. While Bama is just 2-6 as an AF, they are 23-15 as a SEC fav and A&M is just 5-12-1 ATS vs SEC foes & HC Sumlin is just 1-6 ATS off a bye. Roll Tide Roll!

FORECAST: ALABAMA BY 13

2★ Michigan State (+) over MICHIGAN - The Paul Bunyan Trophy will be at stake here. MSU has dominated this series of late going 6-1 SU/7-0 ATS. The HT has gone 4-0 SU and the LTH (+12) the 12 pts MSU all'd were the fewest in a loss s/93 (up 10-9 all'd GW fg w/05). LY #8 MSU won 35-11 (-17) w/a 446-186 yd & 22-13 FD edge. UM is on an epic defensive run after their 3rd str shutout victory LW vs NW 38-0 (-10). The Wolverines all'd less than 200 yds for the 4th time TY as they outgd' NW 380-168. The 38 pts all'd are the fewest through 6 gms for the Wolverines s/85 when Harbaugh was their st'g QB! UM has more td's during their 5 gm win streak than pts all'd. LW MSU held on to beat RU 31-24 (-13). The Spartans had a commanding 489-349 yd edge but needed a td with :43 left to win. MSU has only outgd' foes by 25 ypg while UM is +181 ypg. Sparty realizes the importance of this rivalry and while they haven't played up to their talent level in recent weeks, they will put forth an all out effort this week. Also coming in as a dog will have them motivated and they'll remind the state of Michigan who the best team in the state is once again.

WK 7 OCT 15 (Thur)

Auburn at KENTUCKY - Auburn has won 16 of the L/17 gms incl a 37-34 (-6) win in the L/mtg which was also here (AU came in ranked #8) but UK has covered 3 str incl an outright upset in '09, 21-14 as a 13' AD. Both teams enter fresh off a bye. The Tigers beat SJSt 35-21 (20') at home the wk prior as RB Barber rushed for 5 td's, the most by an AU player s/03 (Cadillac Williams). AU was outgd' & outFD'd but were +4 TO's. The bye week wasn't all quiet on the Plains, however, as they dismissed off troubled WR Duke Williams after a bar brawl. The Tigers are 0-2 in SEC play, and the L/11X they've started that way, they've gone a combined 6-6-2-1 in conf play & 1954 was the only yr they won more than 2! UK needed OT to survive FCS EKU the week prior, winning 34-27 (+31'). Down 27-13 4Q, the 'Cats scored 2 td's in the last 5 min incl the tying one w/52 left to send it into OT. UK had just 384-363 yd & 24-20 FD edges. AU has put an emphasis on the run as they are avg 218 (4.4) rush their L/2 gms while UK is all'g 171 (4.2) rush ypg on the ssn and all'd 247 vs ULL in their opener & 180 in their last gm. AU is on an 0-10 ATS run and are 0-5 as an SEC fav, but UK is just 1-4-1 at home and 7-17-2 ATS in SEC gms.

OCTOBER MARQUEE GOM THIS WEEK!

Wku at NORTH TEXAS - Former SBC foes now playing in CUSA. NT is 4-2 SU/4-1 ATS but has lost 2 str incl 25-24 (+11) in the L/mtg (12). LTH NT lost 31-21 (+1) and the HT is 0-3 ATS. NT fired HC McCarney following their embarrassing 66-7 homecoming loss to FCS Portland St. The Mean Green was outgd' 670-198 and their lone td came with 1:02 left. Not only is NT winless on the season, but they're also 0-5 ATS, failing to cover by an avg of 23 ppg! WKU is 3-0 SU in CUSA play and enter off a 58-28 (-7) home win over MT. The Hilltoppers led 52-14 at HT and finished with a 593-419 yd edge, which was also their 1st home win s/'89 against their rival! QB Doughty continues his fine ssn as he threw for 5 td's and 359 yds while NT is all'g 290 pass ypg and nearly 75% completions.

Ucla at STANFORD - Cardinal have won 7 str (5-2 ATS) incl DD wins in the last 5 reg ssn mtgs. Boise St at UTAH ST - Boise has dominated this series, winning 12 in a row including the L/10 by an avg of 31 ppg. EM has dropped 4 gms in a row, the latest a 47-21 (+7) home loss to Akron as they were down 40-14 at HT. EM is on a 9-20-1 ATS run overall incl 9-14-1 ATS away. UT is on a 7-1-1 ATS run.

TEMPLE by 31 over Ucf - Just the 3rd all-time mtg. UCF has won each of the L2Y incl a 34-14 (-7) win LY outgaining Temple 466-182 (+16 FD). HT has covered both gms. FAU is off an emotionally heartbreaking 27-26 (-4) home loss to Rice after giving up a 12 pt eq lead. The dog is 13-1-1 in FAU gms & FAU is 20-8 as a dog. MU is 6-13-3 as an AF.

LTH OSU dropped 52 forcing TO's on 6 str WSU drives, won 52-24 (E). OSU is 3-0 SU/ATS seeking revenge in this series (+26 ypg, +130 ypg). WSU is coming off an emotional win at Oregon, 45-38 in 2OT (+16'). That was the 1st win over the Ducks in 9 tries for WSU. QB Falk was outstanding, going 50-74-505-5, and led WSU to the GT td with :01 left in the 4Q. OSU is coming off a 44-7 loss to Arizona (+10). OSU was outgd' 644-249 and the Beavers' QB's combined for just 12-35-98-0-1. OSU is 2-12 ATS, 0-5 as an AD and 2-9 ATS in P12 play. WSU is 4-8 ATS and 1-4 as a HF.

UTAH by 8 over Arizona State - ASU is 11-0 and 4-0 in P12 play. ASU had won the first 2 by 25 ppg but in '14 barely escaped with a 19-16 win (-6') in OT. Utah is coming off a big 30-24 win (-7') over Cal with ESPN Gameday on hand. Utah led almost the whole way through despite being outgd' 467-435 & outFD'd 25-21. It was a mistake filled gm with Utah intercepting QB Goff 5X and 1 FR but also had 3 TO's of their own. ASU won LW vs Colorado 48-23 (-16'). BOWLING GREEN by 8 over Akron - This is BG's HC gm. BG is 6-0 SU and 7-0 ATS. UA has not won at BG s/'05. LY BG won 27-10 (+6') despite UA having a 398-389 yd edge & 26-21 FD edge. The Falcons are coming off a win vs UMass 62-38 (-13') in which BG set a ssn high ydg ttl of 725. BG outgd' UMass by 209 yds and have now gone over 500+ yds of offense in all 6 gms TY (605 ttl ypg). UA is coming off a 47-21 win over EMU (-7'). UA outgd' & outFD'd EMU 500-413 & 28-20. Akron led 40-14 at HT behind 6 tds from QB Woodson. UA has outgd' foes by 44 ypg but have been outgd' by 18 ypg on the road. The Zips faced an air raid offense against Oklahoma to start TY and were beaten 41-3 and all'd 439 pass yds. BG is 1-6 as a MAC Fav. Akron is 4-9 ATS but 9-5 as an AD.

Tcu by 21 over IOWA ST - TCU is 5-1 vs ISU. The Frogs are 2-1 s/ joining the B12 (1-2 ATS). In '14 TCU needed to win big to impress the committee and did just that, winning 55-3 (-34'). LW TCU escaped with a victory at Kansas St 52-45 (-9'). TCU trailed 35-17 at HT and 42-31 in the 4Q. The 35 pts all'd in the FH was the most s/'04. QB Boykin accounted for 3 tds in the 4Q rally including a GD 55 yd td pass. ISU lost LW vs TT 66-31 (+10'). ISU all'd TT to set a schl rec for ttl yds (776). Things will not get any easier for the Cyclones vs TCU who have avg'd 616 yds of offense. ISU has been outgd' by 8 ypg while TCU outgd' their foes by 229 ypg. TCU is 14-6 ATS but 3-10 as an AF. ISU is 4-12-1 as a DD Dog and 0-3-1 when +20 or more.

NOTRE DAME by 6 over USC - USC is 10-3 in the battle for the Jeweled Shillelagh but the Irish are 4-2 ATS. In '14 SC won 49-14 (-7') vs a banged up ND squad. The loss was the 2nd most lopsided loss in the 86 gm series. USC is off a shocking 17-12 (-17) loss to UW. It was the 1st time s/'01 that USC lost consecutive home gms. Also worth noting is the fact that it was the 3rd time in 5 games as a DD fav vs P5 Conf tms under HC Sarkisian that the Trojans have lost outright! USC outgd' & outFD'd UW 346-299 & 20-17 but had 3 TO's, a missed FG and were 1-13 on 3D. Just before we went to press, we've learned that Sarkisian won't be on the sidelines for this game due to a personal leave of absence. ND is off a rivalry win vs Navy 41-24 (-13'). The Irish never trailed and outgd' Navy 459-340. LY Kessler threw for 6 tds vs ND's secondary, but the early forecast is calling for rain with temp's in the 50's. ND has all'd 156 pass ypg but that includes 2 gms vs triple option tms. USC is just 5-13 ATS in road games and 3-9 ATS vs rnk'd tms. ND is 6-1 ATS but 4-10 as a Fav vs P5 tms.

Mississippi by 10 over MEMPHIS - Ole Miss is 6-0 (3-1-2 ATS) vs Memphis winning by 12 ppg although Memphis has won 4 of 14 s/'93. In '14 Ole Miss won 24-3 and the Rebels outgd' Memphis 426-104. LW Ole Miss took out some frustration on NMSU, winning 52-3 (-45). Ole Miss outgd' & outFD'd NMSU 665-239 & 31-18. Memphis is off a bye. Prior to the bye, Memphis beat USF 31-24 ('7). Memphis was up 24-10 in the 4Q and all'd a late td. Ole Miss will have to deal with the Memphis offense which avg's 541 ypg and 335 pass ypg. QB Kelly could be in for a huge gm as Ole Miss avg's 340 pass ypg while the Tigers all' 307 ypg. Ole Miss is 5-12 as an AF but 7-2-1 as a DD Fav. Fuente is 5-3 as an AD and 9-2-1 ATS vs NC foes. Ole Miss has a big SEC contest on deck vs TX A&M.

OHIO ST by 21 over Penn St - OSU is 5-1 (6-3 ATS) vs PSU. The HT had gone 8-1 (9-0 ATS) from '98-'06 but the visitor is on a 6-2 run (5-3 ATS). The higher rnk'd tm has gone 22-2 in this series. OSU was once again in a closer than expected gm LW vs Maryland (-31'). The gm was tied at 21 in the 3Q before OSU finally wore out the Terps. OSU scored 28 str before giving up a late td to win 49-28. OSU outgd' MD 499-386 & outFD'd them 31-20. Since losing their opener, PSU has won 5 str. PSU won LW vs a depleted Indiana tm 29-7 (-6') and outgd' & outFD'd IU 420-234 & 22-14. The Nittany Lions have held 4 of their 6 foes to their lowest ydg ttl on the ssn. The Buckeyes have outgd' foes by 160 ypg while PSU has been outgd' by 137 ypg on the road. OSU is 0-6 as a HF.

NEW MEXICO by 7 over Hawaii - This is NM's HC. NM has won the L5 vs UH going back to '93. The only recent gm was in '12, NM won 35-23 (-2). The Lobos are coming off a loss to Nevada 35-17 (+4'). NM was outgd' & outFD'd 517-273 & 30-14. NM trailed just 21-17 in the 4Q after a 77 yd FR for td. NM had a chance to cut the lead to single digits again but fmb'd while reaching for the EZ. UH's offense continued to struggle LW vs SDSU, losing 28-14 (-2). UH was outgd' 402-251. UH is 0-3 as a visitor TY and have been outscored 121-0, although the competition has been stiff to say the least (OSU, Wisky, Boise). UH has been outgd' by 280 ypg on the road this ssn. NM has been outgd' by 23 ypg TY but have outgd' foes by 86 ypg when at home. The Rainbow Warriors have been gashed by the run TY, all'ing 232 rush ypg (4.4 ypc) and now face NM's triple option which avg's 268 ypg (5.5 ypc). Davie is 8-4-1 as a Fav and 4-0 as a MW Fav. UH is 8-18 ATS vs MW foes and 3-6 as an AD.

Oregon by 3 over WASHINGTON - UO is 11-0 SU/ATS with an avg MOV of 25 ppg. In '14 UO won 45-20, and outgd' the Huskies 554-317 & outFD'd 29-20.
