4★ ARKANSAS over Auburn - From 2008-'12 Auburn was 1-4 SU/ATS but the L2Y have gone 2-0 SU/ATS incl a 45-21 win LY (-19). Tigers had a 595-328 yd & 27-20 FD edge. LTH Auburn won 35-17 (-7) but had only a 366-346 yd edge (-7 FD). Arkansas is fresh off a bye & lost to Bama 27-14 (+16) w/ssn lows in yds (220) & FD's (10) the wk prior. Auburn picked up it's 1st SEC win of the ssn, beating UK 30-27 (-2) last Thurs. The Tigers were outg'd 497-407, but led 23-10 at HT & their 407 yds was a ssn high. They also had a ssn high 255 pass yds as they had been held under 200 yds thru the air against every FBS tm they'd ply'd TY. The win also snapped Auburn's 10 gm ATS losing streak! The Hogs were held to a ssn low 44 rush yds in their L/gm, but should be able to find the running lanes a bit easier here as the Tigers are all'g 198 (5.1) rush ypg. Auburn is 2-7 ATS vs conf foes & 7-15 as an AD, while Ark is on a 14-5 ATS run. With a week to prepare and hungry to get their running gm going again, the Hogs should have no problem this week. Woo Pig Sooiel!

3★ Florida State over GEORGIA TECH - The L/2 mtg's have been in the ACC Title gms. FSU has won both by 2 & 6 but GT has covered as 4 & 14 pt dogs. In reg ssn gms FSU is 12-2 but GT pulled the outright upset in '09 49-44 (+3) & LTH ('08) won 31-28 (-2). Yellow Jackets have covered 6 str series gms. LW FSU won over Louisville 41-21 (-6) as we cashed in on a 3★ selection on these pages. FSU outg'd UL 510-406. RB Cook was 22-163-2 despite playing through a hamstringing inj. FSU actually trailed 7-6 at HT but scored 5 tds in 6 poss' in the 2H. GT is coming off a 31-28 loss to Pitt (-3). GT outg'd Pitt 482-391 but most of the damage was in the 1H as GT was held to 149 yds and 7 pts in the 2H. GT has outg'd 3 foes during their 5 gm losing streak but are -59 ypg on the ssn. GT's D has all'd 210 rush ypg (5.5 ypc) in their L/3 and now face RB Cook, whose 955 yds through 6 gms is the most by an ACC RB s/96! GT is 0-5 ATS and we'll call for FSU to win handily over a GT squad that is in free-fall mode.

3★ USC over Utah - First HG for the Trojans since Sarkisian was fired. The only time in series history Utah has won 2 str was 1915-'16! Home tm is 4-0 ATS in P12 gms & USC is 3-1 SU. LY #19 Utah won 24-21 (-1) getting a GW td w/08. LTH USC led 16-3 at HT in the 19-3 win (-4). The gm featured just 461 ttl yds & 27 FD's. USC is off a 41-31 (+5) loss at rival ND. The Trojans had a 31-24 lead in the 4Q, but couldn't hang on as they all'd 17 str to end the gm. USC did have a 590-476 yd edge in their 1st gm since firing HC Sarkisian. Utah remains the lone undefeated tm in the P12 and is coming off a 34-18 (-5) come-from-behind home win over ASU. Down 18-14 in the 4Q, Utes RB Booker scored td's on runs of 25 & 62 yds in the final stanza to pull away. Utah had 369-257 yd & 16-12 FD edges. The yds & FD's all'd were ssn lows. The L2Y Bama has all'd +35 & +55 ypg more than their ssn avg vs the Vols. UT enters fresh off a bye following their come-from-behind 38-31 (+1) win over UGA the wk prior. The Vol's were down 24-3 late 1H & scored the go-ahead td w/5:48 left in the gm. UT was fortunate as UGA star RB Chubb was inj'd on the 1st play from scrimmage. We elevated our 2★ on these pages LW to a 4★ LPS play on Saturday as we easily cashed on Bama in their 41-23 (-3) rout over A&M on the road (Star rated ply's in Power Sweep went 5-1 & are now 18-6 the L4W while our LPS side plays went 4-1 LW & are 16-6 the L3W!) The Tide were up 28-16 late 2Q and weren't really challenged as they had a 396-316 yd edge and forced 4 TO's. UM is off a 30-20 (-3) win over VT, cashing in a 3★ LPS play on Saturday as part of our 4-1 day on college sides (16-6 the L3W!) QB Kaaya hit 19-30-296-2-0 & the Canes had a 395-361 yd edge. Clem's offense was supposed to be tested LW vs BC as the Eagles entered the gm all'g just 185 ypg vs FBS foes & was #1 in the FBS holding foes to 269 yds below their ssn avg, but Tiger QB Watson hit 27-41-420-3-2 as Clem had 532-246 yd & 24-11 FD edges. The Aggies were fortunate as they were actually outFD'd 20-15 & were only +1 in yds, but forced 8 TO's incl 7 in the 1H converted into 35 pts! It was their 1st home win over a ranked foe s/91 (Fresno). We elevated our 3★ on these pages LW (A perfect 4-0 on our key selections) to a 4★ LPS play on Saturday (as part of our 4-1 college sides) & easily cashed with SDSt in their 30-7 (+3) outright upset win at SJSt. RB Pumphrey finished w/207 ttl yds as the Aztecs had dominant 377-148 yd & 23-14 FD edges. Utah St is on a 32-19 run as an AD & SDSt is 3-5 ATS.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 34 over Eastern Michigan - Huskies HC. NIU is 13-1 incl 7 str wins (5-2 ATS) by 35 ppg. LY EM scored a td early 4Q to actually take a 17-14 lead at home (+20) but eventually lost 28-17. LTH EM lost 59-20 (+31) as NIU was ranked #23. EM enters this gm losers of 5 str after their 63-20 (+28) loss at ranked Toledo. The Eagles did lead 6-0 early 2Q, but were then outscored 56-0 before getting a td early 4Q. Surprisingly the FD's were even & EM was outg'd 611-458. NIU is off a 45-12 (-15) win at Miami. RB Bouagnon had 134 (9.6) rush yds & 3 td's as the Huskies had 514-309 yd & 21-17 FD edges. EM is all'g 514 ypg incl an astonishing 345 (6.8) rush ypg as they are all'g 143 ypg more than their opponents avg. NIU is avg 428 ypg incl 202 (4.5) rush ypg. LY (1st mtg s/99) the Rockets won 42-35 (-17) but had just 520-497 yd & 30-26 FD edges (trailed at HT 20-14). UT is 6-0 for the 1st time s/97 and also are ranked in the Top 25. They enter off a 63-20 (-28) blowout win over EM as QB Ely hit 18-27-327-4-0. UT was down 6-0 after 1Q, but then scored 56 str. The Rockets had a 611-458 yd edge. UM tied off a 15-10 (-7) home loss to Kent. The Minutemen had a 10-3 lead late 1H, but went into HT tied at 10 and were shutout in the 2H. UM was outg'd 327-257 and held the ball for just 23:37. The Minutemen are all'g 490 ypg incl 231 (5.1) rush but have also all'd nearly 400 pass yds to Temple and over 500 yds thru the air to BG. Sparty already had the gm covered, but down 2 w/just :10 left and UM forced to punt, the snap was low and the punter couldn't get it off & it was ret'd for a td as time expired for the outright win. MSU did have 386-230 yd & 20-10 FD edges. After opening the ssn 4-0, IU has now dropped 3 str, the latest coming in dramatic fashion as they couldn't hold onto a 25 pt lead and lost 55-52 (-5) at home to Rutgers. The Hoosiers were up 52-27 late 3Q, but had three 4Q TO's & each resulted in td's. They all'd the GW 26 yd fg w/no time left. Under Dantonio the Spartans are 6-0 SU/ATS the gm after playing a ranked UM squad. Hoosiers have lost 11 str B10 AG's (3-8 ATS). MSU is 1-6 ATS, while Indiana is 6-3 ATS but just 5-10 as an AD.

LTH WF pulled the outright upset 28-13 (+7). NCSt is fresh off a bye following their 28-13 (+2) loss at VT the wk prior. The Wolfpack were outg'd 358-270. WF is off a 50-14 (+17) loss at UNC. The Demon Deacons were outg'd 538-310 & outFD'd 22-16. NCSt has a huge schedule edge coming off a bye (15 day rest) while WF is off B2B ACC AG's and has UL in 6 days! NCSt is 9-3 ATS, but is just 3-9 as an AF, while WF is 6-2 as a HD.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 35 over Miami, Oh - Miami is 4-14-1 SU incl 4 str losses (1-3 ATS) in this MAC rivalry. LY WM won 41-10 (-7) getting the 2H shutout, w/a 499-236 yd edge (+5 FD). LTH ('09) Miami had a 421-370 yd & 27-23 FD edge but lost 48-26 (+16, -3 TO). Miami has lost 5 str and is still searching for its 1st win over an FBS foe following their 45-12 (+15) home loss to NIU. The Redhawks were outg'd 514-309 and were down 21-3 at HT. WM is off a 49-14 (+4) outright upset win over Ohio on the road. RB Bogan had a car high 135 rush yds as the Broncos ran for a MAC ssn high 430 yds. WM only led 14-7 at HT, but then scored 28 str to open the 2H. The Broncos had a 567-354 yd edge. Miami is all'g 454 ypg incl 201 (4.9) rush. WM is avg 441 ypg & over their L4 gms is avg 263 (6.3) rush ypg and that even includes a 169 yd effort vs the defending Nat'l Champion Buckeyes. WM is on a 13-4 ATS run in the reg ssn, but Miami is 8-4 as a DD dog.

The Middies were down 21-7 late 2Q & were outg'd 459-340 & outFD'd 27-16 while committing 3 TO's in the gm. We cashed our Oct Marquee GOM on the OVER in FSU's 31-28 (+6, 55) home win over UNLV last Fri. The Bulldogs snapped a 5 gm losing skid (also ATS) as they rallied from a 28-14 late 3Q deficit and scored the final 17 pts, the last coming on a 38 yd td run w/2:37 remaining. MARSHALL by 35 over North Texas - This is homecoming weekend for Marshall. Last/only mtg was in Huntington ('88) in the 1st rd of the 1AA playoffs & the Mean Green lost 7-0. NT has an interim HC and has had 2 extra days to prepare following their 55-28 (+35) home loss to WKU. The Mean Green were down 55-14 & gained 164 of their 431 ttl yds in their 2 late 4Q scoring drives which gave them their 1st cover of the yr after failing to cover their F/5 gms of the yr by an avg of 23 ppg! STANFORD by 17 over Washington - It's homecoming weekend in Palo Alto. Stan is 8-2 but has dropped 3 str ATS. LY Stan only won 20-13 (-7) despite a 365-179 yd & 22-15 FD edges (-3 TO). LTH #5 Stan won 31-28 (-8, #15 Wash) being outg'd 489-279 (-16 FD's!). The Cardinal has had 2 extra days to prepare for this gm after destroying UCLA 56-35 (-6), cashing us our Thurs night Marquee winner. Stan was outg'd, but they were up 56-20 early 4Q & all'd 2 long Bruin td drives in that final stanza. RB McCaffrey (son of former SU & Bronco Ed) had an FBS ssn high 369 all-purpose yds incl a car high 243 rush & 4 td's. UW is off another loss to Oregon (12 in a row) 26-20 (-3) at home. The Huskies were down 16-3 at HT and were outg'd 442-385 & outFD'd 21-17. Stan is avg 451 ypg incl 226 (5.2) rush ypg and are compl 66.2% of their passes, while UW is all'g 423 ypg in conf play. UW HC Petersen is 14-7 as a dog incl 9-1 as a dog of 7 pts, while the Cardinal are 6-2 as a HF.

TEXAS by 7 over Kansas St - Texas is 3-8 SU/2-9 ATS incl a 23-0 (+10) shutout loss LY vs #11 K-St. UT had just 196 yds & 12 FD (-171 yds). LTH the Horns won 31-21 (-6) w/452-390 yd & 24-21 FD edges. UT is fresh off a bye following their emotional 24-17 (+16) outright upset over OU in the RRR. They rushed for a ssn high 313 (5.4) yds, which was their 1st 300+ yd rushing effort vs a P5 conf tm s/12 (350 vs Ole Miss). The 'Horns did have a 368-278 yd edge in the gm. KSU is off a 55-0 (+4) blowout home loss to OU. It was the Wildcats 1st shutout loss s/96 & their 1st shutout loss at home s/91. KSU was absolutely destroyed as they had ssn lows of 110 yds & 7 FD's & all'd ssn highs of 568 yds & 30 FD's! While the 'Horns have struggled overall this ssn, they did have their best outing in their last gm and had a bye to build upon that. UT is 6-2-1 as a fav & 6-3 as a conf fav. KSU is 39-15 ATS vs the B12 & 24-11 as a dog.

MISSISSIPPI by 7 over Texas A&M - This is A&M's first true AG on the ssn. Revenge for the Aggies as before LY they were a perfect 6-0 in the series (Ole Miss 3-0 ATS in SEC gms). #14 A&M lost 35-20 (-3) as Ole Miss came in #3. A&M had 455-338 yd & 27-17 FD edges but were -3 TO's. LTH #9 A&M scored the F/10 pts to win 41-38 (-7, +125 yds & +10 FD's). Both teams enter off crushing defeats.

We elevated our 2★ on these pages LW going against A&M to a 4★ LPS play on Saturday and easily cashed as A&M was crushed 41-23 (+3) vs Bama. The Aggies were down 28-6 late 1H as their QB's combined to throw 3 pick 6's. Ole Miss couldn't hang onto an early 14-0 lead and lost on the road to Memphis 37-24 (-10). The yds were nearly even while the Rebels were outFD'd 31-25. Ole Miss is avg 521 ypg & QB Kelly is avg 319 pass ypg compl 66% while their D is all'g just 292 ypg at home. A&M is avg 453 ypg, but are all'g 229 (5.7) rush ypg and 70.2% completions in conf play. Ole Miss HC Freeze is on a 38-19 ATS run, while A&M is 2-4 as an AD, 1-6 off a SU loss, & is travelling outside of the state of Texas for the 1st time all ssn.

NORTH CAROLINA by 14 over Virginia - NC is 5-0 SU/ATS winning by 20 ppg. LY NC trailed 27-21 4Q. NC incl'd UVA & got a gm deciding td w/4:05 left to win 28-27 (+7, -69 yds & -6 FD). LTH the Tar Heels led 21-0 at HT on their way to a 45-26 (-12) win (446-350 yd & 25-17 FD edges). NC has won 5 str following their ssn opening loss. They enter off a 50-14 (-17) dismantling of WF. The Tar Heels had 538-310 yd & 22-16 FD edges. UVA is off a thrilling 44-38 (-7) 3OT home win over Syr. The 'Hoos were down 21-14 at HT & hit a 25 yd fg w/no time left to force OT. UVA did have 393-334- yd & 25-21 FD edges. NC is avg 482 ypg incl 219 (6.2) rush ypg & are compl 67.5% of their passes as they are #13 in the FBS avg 122 ypg more than what their opponents are all'g. While UVA is all'g just 186 pass ypg in conf play, they are all'g 72% completions. NC is 15-7 as a HF, but UVA is 10-6-1 as a DD dog.

NEBRASKA by 17 over Northwestern - Neb is 6-2 SU but 1-3 ATS in B10 mtg's. LY #19 Neb won 38-17 (-7) w/a 471-290 yd & 25-21 FD edges. LTH NW all'd a 49-yd Hail Mary w/04 up 3, lost 27-24 (-4, -146 yd & -12 FD). Neb is off their best win of the ssn, a 48-25 (+2) outright upset on the road to MN. The Huskers were up 24-14 at HT and had 464-366 yd & 23-18 FD edges and were +3 in TO's as they were not going to be snake bitten again. After starting the yr 5-0 and being ranked, NW has now lost B2B gms by a comb'd score of 78-10. The Wildcats were only down 16-10 at HT, but then were shutout in the 2H of their 40-10 (+1) home loss to Iowa. NW was outg'd 492-198, outFD'd 24-13 and held the ball for just 22:38. Offense hasn't been a problem all ssn for Neb, as they are avg 451 ypg and are #15 in the FBS avg 113 ypg more than their opponents are all'g. The Huskers are however, all'g 433 ypg incl 342 thru air, but only 91 (3.2) rush ypg and match up well with NW. The Wildcats have struggled on offense in B10 play, as they are avg just 226 ypg incl just 91 (2.7) rushing and are compl just 52% of their passes. Wisconsin by 13 over ILLINOIS - Homecoming weekend for the Illini. Wiskey is playing for a 8th str wk & UI is off a bye. Badgers are 14-3-1 incl 5 str wins by 10+ pts but the Illini have covered 5 of the L/8. LY UI led 14-7 2Q but all'd 31 str & lost 38-28 (+26). Wiskey had a 498-279 yd edge. LTH #25 UW won 56-32 (-14). In UI's last gm, they lost 29-20 (+10) at Iowa as they were outg'd 478-363. UW is off a 24-7 (-23) win over PU. The Badgers only led 10-7 at HT despite a substantial 272-61 yd edge at the half. For the gm UW had 26-12 FD & 418-191 yd edges. The Badgers have uncharacteristically gone away from their rush attack the L/2 wks as they've thrown for exactly 322 yds each gm, attempting 50 & 39 passes in the process. VIRGINIA TECH by 8 over Duke - VT HC. VT is 13-1 SU but the HT has dropped 2 str ATS. LY VT got revenge 17-16 (+4, -33 yds) over #19 Duke who LTH snapped a 12-gm series skid & 47-gm losing streak vs ranked foes, VT had 387-198 yd & 19-13 FD edges in the 13-10 (-12) loss. Duke is fresh off a bye following their 44-3 (-12) road win at Army the wk prior, easily cashing a 3★ on these pages. The Blue Devils led 27-0 at HT & finished with 458-168 yd & 25-12 FD edges. VT is off a 30-20 (+3) loss at Miami as we cashed a 3★ LPS play on Saturday going against the Hokies. (Sat LPS side plays now 16-6 the L3W!). They were outg'd 395-361 & were -4 TO's. During Duke's resurgence under Cutcliffe, they have been known an offensive team, but it's their D that has them alive in the Coastal standings as they are all'g just 253 ypg and 43.4% completions on the ssn! They are #25 in the FBS holding their opponents to 86 yds below their ssn avg! VT is on just an 18-37-1 ATS run vs FBS foes. Duke has incredible tech edges as they are 21-8 ATS away, 8-2 as an ACC dog, 20-9-1 ATS overall and are 11-1 SU on the road!

IDAHO by 1 over Ulm - ID HC. ID is 1-3 SU but covered LY (lost 38-31 +14) in the only mtg s/04. The Vandals were outg'd 534-442 (-4 FD). LTH ('04) ID was shutout at HT & lost 16-14 (+1). ULM is coming off a 59-14 (+13) beating by App St in which ULM was outg'd 654-350! ULM has been outg'd by every FBS foe they have faced by 216 ypg. ID is coming off an outright upset over Troy 19-16 (+10). ID was outg'd 381-330 but was +4TO's incl 2 deep in ID territory. The Vandals jumped out to a 16-3 lead but needed a GD FG in the 4Q. ID has also been outg'd by every FBS foe they have faced by 185 ypg. ID is 5-19 SU, 4-14 ATS at home and has not won more than 1 HG in a ssn s/10. ULM is 16-8 ATS away.

LTH #19 UCF won 19-14 (-12) as UH was SPD from the UCF7. UH has had an extra day to prepare following their 42-7 (-19) blowout win at Tulane. The Cougars became the 1st AAC tm to become bowl elig as WR Ayers had 283 all-purp yds & QB Ward was excellent again hitting 17-25-222-1-1 while adding 77 rush yds & 3 td's. UH had 461-262 yd & 24-11 FD edges & led 28-7 at HT. UCF lost LW vs Temple 30-16 (+21). UCF actually led 16-14 in the 4Q, their first 4Q lead over an FBS foe s/wk1. UCF was held to just 134 ttl yds and the def scored their only td on an int ret. UCF is 1-7 ATS & 5-11-1 as a HD. UH is on a 21-10-1 ATS run, is 28-16 as a fav & 13-0-1 away!

Colorado by 3 over OREGON STATE - OSU is 5-2 SU incl 2-0 SU in P12 mtg's. Visitor has gone 0-2 ATS. LY OSU won 36-31 (-6). LTH the Beavers had 540-300 yd & 29-14 FD edges on their way to an easy 44-17 (-11) win. CU is coming off a close loss to Arizona, 38-31 (+7) as we cashed another Underdog POW on these pages (4-0 on our key selections)! CU led 24-17 in the 4Q. CU was only outFD'd 26-22. OSU lost LW to WSU 52-31 (+7). OSU all'd 45 1H pts and was outg'd 520-394. OSU is -82 ypg on the ssn but is +99 ypg at home while CU is +18 ypg but is -42 ypg on the road. OSU is 2-5 ATS off a SU loss. CU is 3-10 ATS away.

BAYLOR by 42 over Iowa St - BU HC. The Bears are 5-2 SU/4-2-1 ATS in this B12 rivalry. The LZY Baylor has won by an avg of 60-18 w/658-257 yd & 32-14 FD edges (combined 72-7 HT score). MISSISSIPPI ST by 10 over Kentucky - UK is 0-6 SU/1-4-1 ATS. LY the Bulldogs won 45-31 (-14) w/542-504 yd & 30-23 FD edges. LTH UK lost 28-22 but covered as 11 pt AD's. MSU still had solid 447-325 yd & 24-20 FD edges. UK has had 2 extra days of rest but MSU is playing their 3rd str HG (1st 2 opp's non-P5). The Wildcats are off an emotional 30-27 (+2) home loss to Auburn in front of a sellout crowd in their 1st Thurs night home gm s/1939! UK was driving with a chance to at least tie the gm but were SOD at the AU 46 with :25 left. They had a 497-407 yd edge but had a costly TO in the RZ. The 497 yds was a ssn high. MSt also faced Auburn TY and won 17-9 (+2) despite being outg'd by 63 yds. MSt is off a win over Louisiana Tech 45-20 (-10). MSt trailed 14-0 early but came back to take a 24-17 HT and pulled away in the 2H. UK is 3-8-1 ATS and 5-9 as an AD. The 'Cats are 6-16-1 as Dogs vs SEC foes while the MSt is 12-4-1 as Fav vs SEC foes.

OKLAHOMA by 19 over Texas Tech - OU is 16-6 SU and the home tm has gone 7-2 ATS. LY OU won 42-30 (-13) holding a 517-486 yd & slight 25-23 FD edge. LTH #17 OU beat #10 TT 38-30 (-6) w/a 526-460 yd edge. Over the L3Y the Sooners have held TT under their ssn avg (-68 ypg). OU is coming off a rare blowout win over Kansas ST, 55-0 (-4). The Wildcats hadn't been shutout s/96 and hadn't been shutout at home s/91. OU had 568-110 yd & 30-7 FD edges! OU is 7-11 as a B12 fav and 3-5 as a HF. TT is coming off a closer than expected win over Kansas, 30-20 (-32). TT outg'd KU 576-475 and led 20-0 at HT but needed a late INT ret for td to finish the Jayhawks off. OU all's just 152 pass ypg while TT avg's 428 pass ypg. TT has done a good job of keeping QB Mahomes clean, only giving up 7 sks on the ssn but face OU's pass rush which has 21 sks and all's less than 50% comp. OSU is off a 38-10 (-19) win over Penn St. OSU pressured QB Hackenberg, picking up 5 sks and forcing bad passes all night. OSU outg'd PSU 429-315 & outFD'd them 25-14. QB Barrett accounted for 4 of OSU's tds and may have finally closed the door on the qb debate. RU won a wild shootout vs Indiana 55-52 (+5). RU trailed 52-27 in the 3Q but scored 28 str pts, incl the GW FG as time expired! RU was outg'd 627-596 & outFD'd 28-25 but held IU to just 2-10 on 3D. FAU is coming off a 33-17 (+3) loss to Marshall. MU controlled the ball with a TOP of 35:18. FAU was outg'd 500-334 & out FD'd 26-17. FAU has been outg'd on the road by 38 ypg but UTEP has been outg'd at home by 59 ypg. FAU is 1-3-1 as an AF while UTEP is on a 0-7-2 ATS run incl 1-4 as a HD.

NEW MEXICO ST by 3 over Troy - Series is tied at 1-1. The home tm is 2-0 SU/ATS. LY Troy won 41-24 (-7, led 20-7 at HT) w/571-395 yd & 27-20 FD edges (both ssn high's for the Trojans). LTH ('04) Troy lost outright 22-18 (-10) in a ssn they went to their 1st bowl in program history. Troy was upset LW vs Idaho (-10) despite holding a 381-330 yd edge. The Trojans fell behind 16-3 at HT but fought back in the 4Q with 13 str to tie before ID kicked the GD FG. Troy drove 60/14pl but missed a 32 yd FG to tie. LTH ('98) the Lobos lost 37-20 (-7) in former HC Long's 1st yr at the helm. NM is off a 28-27 (-5) home win over UH. After UH missed a 22 yd FG, NM went 80/10 pl for the GD td. NM was outg'd 415-392 but outFD'd UH 28-23. LW SJSt lost to SDSt 30-7, as the Spartans potent offense was held in check. SJSt managed just 35 rush yds (1.0) and was outg'd 377-148 & outFD'd 23-14! There should be more running room for SJSt against NM who has all'd 293 rush ypg in their L3. NM should also find room on the ground against a Spartans D that all's 228 rush ypg (5.1 ypc). NEVADA by 10 over Hawaii - Wolf Park are 4-0 SU/3-0 ATS. LY UN won 26-18 (-3) w/a 427-303 yd & 26-16 FD edge but UH did lead 10-0 & only trailed 16-10 into the 4Q. LTH Hawaii had a 376-340 yd & 20-10 FD edge but lost 31-9 (+7) thanks to -5 in TO's. LW UH (+5) was in position to win vs New Mexico but missed a FG that would have given them a 9 pt lead. NM then drove 80/10pl for the GW td. Hawaii outg'd NM 415-392 but was outFD'd 28-23. UN is off a 28-21 (-6) loss to Wyoming. UN trailed 28-7 in the 3Q but cut the deficit to 7 late in the 4Q. Nevada had one chance to tie but was SOD at the WY 36. UN was outg'd 485-405 but outFD'd WY 27-25. This is UH's 5th trip inland in 7 wks and they are 0-4, 2-2 ATS. In a game that featured 71 pts and 990 tll yds, the Lions were able to escape with a 3 point OT win against the Bears (1st victory of the ssn). Not much has gone in favor of DET so far in '15 as they are 2-9 ATS as a dog and have a long trip across the pond to England on the horizon. MIN meanwhile is on a current 12-3 ATS run and got their ssn kickstarted in their earlier matchup with a 10 pt win over the Lions in Wk 2 (led 26-10 in the 4Q while holding DET to just 38 rush yds).

FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 9

3★ WASHINGTON over Tampa Bay - While the Bucs have already tied LY's win total at 2 following their win over JAX in Wk 5, they do return from their bye week with the worst scoring defense in the league (29.6 ppg). They now travel to DC to take on a Redskins squad (delivered an outright 27-7 upset LY as a 7 pt dog). This is a different WAS team so far at FedExField however as they've outgained their home foes by 117 ypg which included a pair of outright upsets against STL and PHI. Despite a 13-10 lead at HT, the Redskins faltered in the 2H against the Jets (outscored 24-7, held to just 225 yds in the game). DAL is expected to go with Cassel at QB (72 car sts) for the ineffective Weeden who moved to 5-19 in his career as a str (0-3 TY) in this one with the return of WR Bryant still up in the air as of presstime (CS). The Giants head into MNF against the Eagles riding a 3-gm winning streak that has seen them climb to the top of the NFC East standings. They will clearly be looking for revenge following a 10 pt blown lead in the 4Q in Dallas that featured some poor decisions by both Manning and the NY coaching staff. While we'll lean with the hometown squad off a short wk against a starting QB that has been with the team less than a month, keep in mind that the dog is on a current 8-2-1 run in Giants games with DAL winning each of their past 3 trips to MetLife Stadium. **FORECAST: NY GIANTS by 1**

OTHER GAMES

Seattle at SAN FRANCISCO - TNF - The last 3 trips to the Bay Area in this series have been low scoring affairs with an avg of 26 ppg (SF has won 2 of 3). The 49ers have clearly been a different team at home TY with a pair of solid wins incl a 5 pt win a wk ago against the Ravens. While SEA is on an 8-4-1 ATS run vs DIV foes, there is clearly some issues that need to be addressed as their late collapse to the Panthers moved them to 2-4 on the year (wins came over CHI & Det who have combined for 3 wins TY). While this series has lost some of its luster with the departure of Harbaugh, the 49ers and Seahawks each have their back against the wall heading into this one. We'll have one of our Red-Hot Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk.

† Buffalo by 10 over Jacksonville - London - This is a 9:30 am EST start. The Jags were unable to deliver in a rare role as a favorite LW against HOU (just 2nd time in 4 ssn) as they dropped their 8th game in the past 10 contests vs their rival despite a small yardage edge as 3 int's by QB Bortles incl yet another pick-6 (6th in 19 career sts) did them in. The Bills meanwhile continue their zig-zag start to the year by alternating wins (over IND, MIA & TEN) with losses (NE, NYG and LW vs CIN). While London has slowly become a home away from home for JAX (3rd consec ssn here), keep in mind that they've been thrashed by SF and DAL the past 2 yrs by a 73-27 combined score. BUF may be dealing with some key injuries on the offensive side of the ball heading across the pond (CS on QB Taylor and WR Watkins) but we'll roll with their recent trend as this is their week to deliver a win while the Jaguars have continued to falter as a dog with just a 12-23-2 ATS mark.

ST LOUIS by 1 over Cleveland - Despite plenty of opportunities to knock DEN from their undefeated pedestal LW at home (Manning 3 int's), the Browns were unable to deliver a 2nd consec OT victory as the Broncos hit the GW FG on their 2nd drive of the extra frame (CLE tfl'd and sk'd twice on their only drive of OT that started in DEN territory). The Rams return from their bye week displaying some mixed results so far in '15 with solid wins against both SEA and ARZ to go along with some questionable contests at WAS and home against PIT. A once solid home field edge for the Rams inside the dome has disappeared as they have gone just 11-19 ATS as a HF. The Browns on the other hand have been firing on all cylinders as an AD (7-2-1 ATS) including an outright upset of BAL a few wks back. While we'll lean with the Rams for the outright victory, the Browns should stay within the spread with the potential returns of both CB Haden and S Gipson to their secondary.

Pittsburgh at KANSAS CITY - The bottom has fallen out for the Chiefs following their 16-10 defeat a week ago at MIN, a game in which they were held scoreless for the first 3 quarters (KC is on a 3-8 ATS run). The Steelers meanwhile moved to 6-1 ATS as a HD the past 6 yrs by knocking off the Cardinals 25-13 behind 3rd string QB Landry Jones (8-12-168, 2 TD's) who took over in the 3Q for Vick (PIT outgained 469-310, +3 in TO's). This is a key spot in the year for PIT as they are on the verge of getting Roethlisberger back (CS) and have a 3-gm home stretch on deck against CIN, OAK and CLE to get fully back into the playoff mix. KC on the other hand has surprisingly struggled at Arrowhead TY including a blown 17-3 lead to CHI just 2 wks ago. With a trip to London on deck against DET for the Chiefs and questions on who will be starting at QB for the Steelers, we're going to have to wait and see where the line moves in this one before making a decision.

MIAMI by 2 over Houston - HOU HC O'Brien comes into Miami feeling pretty good about his decision to switch to QB Hoyer as he threw for nearly 300 yds and 3 TD's in the win over JAX as a rare dog in the series (1st time s/10, forced 3 Bortles int's). The Dolphins meanwhile returned from their bye week with a chip on their shoulder under new HC Campbell as they throttled TEN 38-10 as a 3 pt AD forcing 4 Titans TO's and outgaining them by a 434-299 clip in the process. Despite much needed momentum coming in, this appears to be a tough spot for the Dolphins (13-33 ATS as HF) to cover as they have a short week on deck with a TNF trip to NE.

NEW ENGLAND by 14 over NY Jets - This matchup has lost a bit of its luster with Rex Ryan now out of the equation. The Patriots can now put "Deflategate" to rest following their 34-27 win over IND last wk, a game in which they all'd the Colts to steal away the backdoor cover w/1:26 remaining. The Jets meanwhile proved yet again that their defense is among the NFL's elite following their win over WAS as they held the Redskins to just 14 FD's and 225 yds in their 14 pt win. Despite an impressive 9-4 ATS mark against AFC East foes and a chance to move into 1st place here with a victory, we'll continue to ride the "Tom Brady Scorched Tour" as the Patriots are still a team that we cannot resist siding with despite LW's late blown cover.

Atlanta by 7 over TENNESSEE - The Falcons dropped their 1st game of the ssn last Thur against the Saints as they routinely shot themselves in the foot during the 1H with 2 TO's in NO territory, a botched 4th down handoff as well as having a punt blk'd for a TD. TEN meanwhile has now dropped 8 consec home gms following a beating at the hands of the Dolphins (outgained 434-299, 4 TO's). With TEN boasting porous records as both a dog (5-14-2) and against N DIV foes (4-12), we feel pretty good about the Falcons returning to the win column in this one (Titans just 2-13 ATS off a SU loss).

INDIANAPOLIS by 3 over New Orleans - The Colts have struggled outside of the AFC South the past 3 ssn with just a 10-13 SU & ATS mark including LW's loss to the Patriots, a game in which they earned the backdoor cover w/1:26 remaining in their 7 pt loss. The Saints meanwhile head to Indy with extra rest and much needed momentum following their upset victory over the undefeated Falcons at the Superdome (forced 3 TO's incl blk'd punt for a TD). While both tms have clearly played far below expectations through the first 6 gms of the ssn, keep in mind that the Saints should be able to stay within the line as their 25 new players on the opening day roster (most in NFL for '15) have begun to settle in and pay dividends having now grasped the new system a 3rd of the way into the year.

SAN DIEGO by 2 over Oakland - After a pair of solid wins over BAL and CLE, the Raiders headed into their bye week with a pair of close losses under their belt against CHI and DEN. They now take on a Chargers squad that they've dropped 6 of the past 7 against. SD also comes into this matchup with just a pair of victories so far in '15 although they did nearly pull off the outright upset LW in GB behind QB Rivers who became just the 17th QB in NFL history to pass for more than 500 yds (late goalline stand by the Packers gave them a 7 pt win). This is a rough spot for the Chargers trend-wise as they've gone just 2-7 ATS as a DIV HF while OAK is 19-8 ATS as a DIV AD. While we'll go ahead and call for SD to get the win, a spread of more than a FG may be too much for them to overcome as OAK HC Del Rio is very familiar in defending the SD offense during his time as the DC in Denver.

Philadelphia at CAROLINA - SNF - We've seen plenty of the Eagles so far this ssn in front of a national audience as they are off of their 2nd matchup on MNF so far this ssn (1-6 ATS after) and now head into their 3rd primetime meeting against an undefeated Panthers squad who delivered a come-from-behind victory a week ago in SEA (25-14 FD and 383-334 yd edges). While the Eagles have clearly faced a tougher schedule and have the opportunity to lay it all on the line with a bye on deck, keep in mind that CAR has proven to be a strong HF over recent yrs with a solid 13-6-2 ATS mark. **Call your VIP Debit Card for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Baltimore at ARIZONA - MNF - The Cardinals return home in the midst of a 3-gm sandwich against the AFC North although things didn't go as planned on their trip to PIT as they coughed up the ball on 3 occasions and lost by 12 despite 21-14 FD and 469-310 yd edges. The Ravens meanwhile continue their tour west of the Mississippi with their 4th such contest so far TY after their narrow loss in SF a wk ago to move their ssn record to 1-6. While ARZ has proven to be impressive as a HF under Arians with a 9-3-1 ATS mark, keep in mind that Harbaugh and company have been in some very tight contest so far this ssn with their 6 losses being decided by just 22 total points.
