4★ Colorado over ARIZONA - CU can't afford a slip up here as they remain in control to reach their 1st P12 Title gm, while AZ has nothing left to play for other than pride as they've already been eliminated from the post ssn & has lost 6 straight. In P12 play, CU is +138 ypg, while AZ is -120 ypg. The Buff's are holding their conf foes to 92 ypg below their ssn avg, while the Cats are all'g 66 ypg more than their opp's avg. RB Lindsay had a 200 yd perf against the other P12 schl from AZ & the Cats are all'g 231 (5.6) rush ypg in conf play. CU is 0-4 SU in this series & failed to cover for the 1st time LW (8-1 ATS), while AZ is 1-8 ATS TY. We feel the Buff's begin a new ATS streak in a big way here!

FORECAST: Colorado by 28

3★ UCLA over Oregon St - With Rosen OFY UCLA is being guided by a former walk on (but did throw for 464 vs Utah!). One more loss for the Bruins will officially leave them home for the holidays, while OSt already has 7 losses. UCLA is +9 ypg in P12 play, while OSt is -108 ypg. UCLA's run gm has struggled, but Soso Jamabo could be in line for a breakout gm as the Beavers are all'g 260 (5.6) rush ypg in conf play. UCLA is 9-2 ATS in this series, while OSt is 5-8 as an AD & got a lucky cover LW in that role. The Beavers luck ran out LW & UCLA will keep their bowl elig alive.

FORECAST: UCLA by 20

3★ VIRGINIA TECH over Georgia Tech - There may not be a better cch in the country at defending GT's option than VT DC Foster as his D's have held the Yellow Jackets to just 183 rush ypg the L4Y w/GT avg 302 in that span! The Hokies must win to remain in control of their ACC Title gm destiny. In conf play, GT is all'g 47 ypg more than their opp's avg, while VT is holding their opp's to 87 ypg less than their avg. VT QB Evans has a 21-2 ratio & didn't throw a td pass for the 1st time LW & GT rates #103 in our pass eff D rankings. VT is 3-0 vs FBS foes as a HF TY.

FORECAST: VIRGINIA TECH by 24

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ San Diego St over NEVADA - SDSt RB DJ Pumphrey is on pace to become the FBS car leader in rush yds & despite 8 straight gms over 100, was held to his 2nd lowest ttl LW. He'll likely pad his stats again TW as NV is all'g 302 (5.8) rush ypg & their D is all'g MW foes 68 ypg more than their ssn avg. SDSt is 7-2 as an AF vs MW foes & NV is 1-4 as a HD.

FORECAST: San Diego St by 28

2★ California (+) over WASHINGTON ST - When you think of Wazzu you think of HC Leach. When you think of HC Leach, you think 'Air Raid' OFF & no D. Well, think again as the Cougars are holding their P12 opp's to 53 ypg below their ssn avg! Cal on the other hand, runs a similar type of OFF, but is all'g their conf foes 111 ypg more than their avg! Wazzu QB Falk has a 28-5 ratio & the Bears have our #86 ranked pass eff D. Wazzu checks in with our #50 pass eff D & Cal has an NFL caliber QB in Davis Webb running the OFF so the Bears can keep it close. The Visitor is 10-2 ATS in this series.

FORECAST: WASHINGTON ST by 7

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 9TH

† Northern Illinois vs Toledo - Gm ply'd at US Cellular Field in Chicago, home to MLB's White Sox. Against 2 common foes (CM, BG) TU is +11 ppg & +50 ypg, while NIU is +10 ppg & +10 ypg. Both feature power run gms w/a 2 headed monster attack as TU's Hunt & Swanson have comb'd for 1,230 (4.9), while NIU's Bouagnon & Maddie have comb'd for 1,202 (5.7). The Rockets are all'g 138 (4.6) rush ypg in Mac play, while the Huskies are all'g 170 (4.1). NIU is on a 4-8 ATS run, while the Rockets are on a 17-6 ATS run.

Bowling Green at AKRON - UA has lost 3 of 4, but is still just 1 win away from becoming bowl elig. Vs 2 common foes (ToI, Mia) the Zips are -4 ppg & -70 ypg, while BG is -11 ppg & -11 ypg. Surprisingly BG is -45 ypg in Maction & UA is -102 ypg! Both struggle on D. Zips QB Woodson ret'd from inj 2 gms ago, but is compl just 55% since returning, while Falcons QB Morgan has an 11-5 ratio his L/3 gms. BG is #127 in our pass eff D rankings, while UA is #121. BG is 38-19-1 ATS in road gms, while UA is 5-8 ATS off a DD loss & the Falcons are 8-0 ATS in the series.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 10TH

North Carolina at DUKE - While Duke remains winless in ACC action, NC is fighting for a trip to the Conf Title gm. QB Trubisky has a sensational 19-2 ratio, while Duke has just our #54 ranked pass eff D. RB Hood has B2B gms over 100 yds & the Blue Devils are all'g 279 rush ypg their L/3. Duke RB Jones filled in for Duncan & had 99 yds LW as the Blue Devils have had B2B gms of 225+ rush yds & NC is all'g 213 (4.3) rush ypg in conf play. This is Duke's home finale, while NC has just an FCS foe on deck. Duke is 11-5 as an ACC HD, but NC is 6-1 as an AF & is 12-7 ATS in this series.

UL Lafayette at GEORGIA SOUTHERN - 1st mtg. Both are still alive for a bowl birth. ULL has lost 4 of 5, while GS has lost 5 of 6. LY GS avg 363 (6.5) rush ypg & all'd 338 ttl ypg, but TY they're avg 242 (4.4) rush ypg & all'g 395 ttl ypg. ULL has had 2 byes in the last month to help prep for the option & in SBC action is all'g 120 (3.1) rush ypg. RB McGuire has been banged up TY & has had an up and down ssn, but could find running lanes this week. ULL is 21-10 as an AD, while GS is 1-3 as a HF, but the Eagles did break an 0-6 overall ATS slide LW.

Utah at ARIZONA ST - Inj's have plagued ASt as they're -214 ypg in P12 action & their D is all'g 75 ypg more than their conf opp's avg. Utah is still fighting for a Conf Title gm birth & is +15 ypg in P12 play. The Sun Devils play much better at home as they're 5-0 ATS & +11 ppg. Since their 62-20 win at Oregon LY, the Utes are 2-4 ATS on the P12 road & 0-2 as a conf AF. ASt is 3-1 as a HD (2-0 TY).

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11TH

Boston College at FLORIDA ST - BC has struggled vs the top ACC foes, losing 49-0 to VT, 56-10 to CU & 52-7 to UL LW & now must travel. FSU nearly allowed the CU loss from 2 wks ago linger into LW, but pulled out the win late. In ACC action the Noles are +14X ypg,

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while BC is -166 ypg. Something must give as FSU is avg 108 ypg more than their opp's allow, but the Eagles are all'g 99 ypg less than their opp's avg. FSU is 0-3 as a HF TY, while BC is 6-2 as AD & the visitor is 8-3 ATS in this series.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 12TH

Northwestern by 21 over PURDUE - NW is still fighting for bowl elig, while PU is in the midst of another losing ssn w/an interim HC on the sideline. NW WR Carr leads the B10 avg 112 ypg & PU rates #88 in our pass eff D rankings. This will be a huge step down for the Wildcats after ply'g OSU & UW in B2B wks. The Boilermakers have ply'd 2 B10 HG's & lost to PSU by 38 & were trailing IO 42-14 in the 4Q & scored down the stretch vs bkps. NW is 3-0 ATS on the B10 road, covering by an avg of 21 ppg!

CLEMSON by 24 over PITTSBURGH - CU QB Watson inj his shoulder LW & sat out the 2H as a precaution, but could've ply'd if needed. All the Tigers need to do is win by a single pt from here on out & they will be in the playoffs, but they went ahead and plastered Syr, who lost their st'g QB in the 1Q. Pitt needs 1 more win to become bowl elig & have HG's vs Duke & Syr after this. The Panthers are just #108 in our pass eff D rankings, so look for Watson to be able to pad his stats. Pitt had been 3-0 ATS on the road until LW's blowout loss. CU is 28-18-1 as a HF & we feel will get another blowout victory this week.

UCF by 7 over CINCINNATI - This offsn UC changed their OFF & 3 QB's later, they still are having trouble moving the ball. Not even a move to former PS#1QB Kiel has worked. After having success vs EC, the Bearcats have been ineffective the L/2 wks. UCF needs just 1 more win to become bowl elig, but is -97 ypg in AAC action, while UC, despite their struggles, is close at -127 ypg. The Knights have our #17 ranked pass eff D, so it will be a surprise if UC shows improvement thru the air here. Remove LY's outlying yr & UCF is 7-2 as a HF. Despite those many factors pointing in UCF's favor, we think UC keeps it a tad closer than expected.

Ohio St by 31 over MARYLAND - MD remains 1 gm short of becoming bowl elig & has Neb & RU on deck, while OSU remains in control of their post ssn fate. The Buckeyes ply'd their best gm LW s/defeating RU 58-0. QB Barrett has a 21-4 ratio, but MD has our #38 ranked pass eff D, however in B10 play, the Buckeyes are avg 250 (5.5) rush ypg & the Terps allow 261 (5.7). The wk after OSU defeated RU, UM did them in even better & now a wk after UM crushed MD, can OSU try to one up their biggest rival? We believe so! MD is 3-7 as a DD dog.

Penn St by 10 over INDIANA - Perhaps the least talked about hottest tm in the country right now is PSU. Don't let the UM gm fool you, as 'LB U' was down their top 5 players from that unit in that gm & all they've done since is win 5 straight, including beating potential playoff bound OSU. While IU is +36 ypg & PSU is +55 ypg in conf play, remove the outlier UM gm & the Nittany Lions are +131 ypg! PSU RB Barkley is avg 169 rush ypg his L/4 & IU is all'g 184 (4.2) rush ypg in B10 play.

LOUISVILLE by 35 over Wake Forest - L'Ville just can't help themselves. After another blowout win LW, HC Petrino suggested they should've put 80 up on the Noles instead of taking their starters out as they are getting no love from the playoff committee. They have by far the most explosive OFF in the nation led by leading Heisman candidate QB Jackson who is coming off yet another crazy perf w/7 ttl td's. WF became bowl elig for the 1st time s/'11 LW so are off an emotional high, while the Cards are still trying to show up the voters. WF all'd IU over 600 yds & NCSt over 525 yds on the road & now must contain Jackson & Co on the road?

Iowa St by 3 over KANSAS - Each of these schls has won just 1 gm, but IST did beat an FBS tm. In B12 play IST is -106 ypg, while KU is -170 ypg. Cyclone leading rusher RB Warren was out LW (personal), but perhaps they were saving him to face a KU rush D that is all'g 271 rush ypg their L/4. Things are diff however, home/away for both. KU is +41 ypg home, while IST is -127 ypg away. The Jayhawks only lost to TCU by 1 & outply'd OSU, but all'd 1 & 8 yd td 'drives' due to TO's. In conf play, IST is holding their opp's to 3 yds less than their avg, while KU is surprisingly doing better at holding their opponents to 24 yds less than their avg. The HT is 12-6-1 ATS. The last time IST was an AF here in '14, they lost outright 34-14 (-3).

EAST CAROLINA by 7 over Smu - SMU proved to be fools gold, getting dominated at home LW vs Memph, while EC enters having lost 6 of 7 as the Pirates continue to be shredded on D. QB Nelson was benched LW after hitting 9-13-100 & bkp Minshew came on & threw for 336 in relief. SMU rates #44 in our pass eff D rankings. In AAC play EC is +10 ypg, while SMU is -49 ypg. After avg 203 (4.9) rush ypg in non conf play, the Ponies are rushing for just 132 (3.6) in the AAC, while EC is all'g 224 (5.4) vs conf foes. SMU is 3-1 as an AD, while EC is 2-7 as a HF. In the series SMU is 3-1 ATS & the visitor is 4-2 ATS.

Miami, Oh by 6 over BUFFALO - UM hasn't been bowling s/'10. After st'g the ssn 0-6, it appeared that streak would continue, but 'Not so fast my Friend!' The Redhaws have won & cov'd 4 straight & are the hottest tm in the MAC not named WM. All 4 wins have come s/ QB Ragland took over & he has a perfect 10-0 ratio & UB has just our #89 ranked pass eff D. UM hasn't been an AF s/'12, while the Bulls are 6-3 as a HD (3-1 TY). The Redhaws will get the win, but the Bulls keep it close.

Nc State by 7 over SYRACUSE - Both have identical overall records, but Syr has 1 more conf victory. Orange QB Dungey was inj (shoulder) 1Q LW (CS) & they were held to a ssn low on OFF as they have a new system TY & bkp Wilson was in over his head. The diff in this matchup is on D as Syr is all'g their conf opp's 72 ypg more than their avg, while the Wolfpack is all'g 5 ypg less than their opp's avg. Syr rates #79 in our pass eff D's, while NCSt QB Finley has B2B 300+ yd gms vs BC & FSU. The dog is 5-0 ATS in this series w/4 outright upsets.

OKLAHOMA ST by 7 over Texas Tech - TT is all'g their B12 foes 73 ypg more than their avg & now they have the task of stopping an OSU tm that just put up 637 yds on a Bill Snyder cch'd tm LW. OSU has our #65 ranked pass eff D, while TT comes in at #100. While neither is effective at stopping the run, the Pokes have at least shown their capable rushing as Justice Hill has three 100+ yd gms TY. While the HT is 10-4 SU, the visitor is 5-1 ATS. This is OSU's home finale, but TT is 6-2 as an AD.

TEXAS A&M by 14 over Mississippi - A&M wasn't getting into the playoffs anyway, but their loss LW (playoff pressure & QB inj) officially knocked them out, while Ole Miss needs to win 2 of their L/3 just to get to a bowl & struggled vs a below avg GS tm LW as QB Kelly was inj (OFY). Despite contrasting records, Ole Miss is just -10 ypg in SEC play, while A&M is -39 ypg. The Rebels 5 losses have come by an avg of 8 ppg. Since his 217 yd effort vs Tunn, Aggie RB Williams is avg just 33 (2.7), but Ole Miss is all'g 6.0 rush ypc in SEC play. Ole Miss is 4-0 ATS in this series.

CHARLOTTE by 17 over Rice - Rice has the distinction of being the worst FBS tm in the nation after getting embarrassed at home by FAU LW. They're last in the nation on D all'g 136 ypg more than their opp's avg & are -216 ypg in CUSA play. CU returns home after B2B road wins & is just -9 ypg in conf action. 49ers RB Phillips is avg 134 rush ypg his L/4 & the Owls are all'g 214 (5.0) rush ypg away. CU has never been a HF vs an FBS schl & Rice is 3-8-1 as an AD. The Owls are -28 ppg & -318 ypg on the road TY. Don't look now, but CU in a bowl? They need to win here to have a chance & will get it done.

ARKANSAS ST by 27 over New Mexico St - After st'g the yr 0-4, A&M has won 4 straight & is in a 3 way tie for 1st in the SBC standings. This is their home finale & they have a HUGE gm vs fellow conf unbetean Troy on deck. NMSt is 0-5 SU on the road, losing by 31 ppg & 0-2 on the SBC road, losing by 39 ppg. The Aggies are all'g their conf opp's 104 ypg more than their ssn avg & A&M is avg 190 (4.3) rush ypg & look for RB's Wand & White to see big holes vs a NMSt rush D that is all'g 256 (5.8) rush ypg away. A&M is 5-0 ATS in this series & 21-12 as a HF, while the Aggies are 6-14 as an AD.

Wyoming by 10 over UNLV - WY found itself in an unusual position LW following their upset win over Boise, sitting alone in 1st place in the MW Mountain Div. They didn't fall into any pressure as they whipped UTSt & now face a UNLV tm 1 loss away from being eliminated from the postssn. RB Hill continues to run wild avg 167 rush ypg the L/5 & UNLV is all'g 194 (4.8) rush ypg away & 73 ttl ypg more than their conf foes avg. Do we even have to mention that Hill ran for 232 yds in LY's mtg? The HT is 5-2 ATS in this series, but the Rebels are 1-7 as a HD, while the Pokes are on a 13-6 overall ATS run.

AIR FORCE by 7 over Colorado St - AF not only became bowl elig LW, but also won the Commander-In-Chief Trophy after their emotional win at Army, while C&M needs 1 more win to become bowl elig themselves. Bkp QB Worthman filled in nicely, throwing for nearly 200 yds. The Rams had a span of 4 straight gms all'g an avg of 247 rush ypg mid ssn, so look for AF to capitalize on that. C&M is +70 ypg in MW action while the Falcons are +14 ypg. AF is 6-3 ATS in this series & are 11-3-1 ATS at home.

ALABAMA by 35 over Mississippi St - We won our GOY in 1992 in this matchup! M&M pulled off the outright upset over A&M LW, but the odds are stacked to do so again TW. Bama continued to show why they have the nations best D in their win over LSU LW as they're holding their opp's to 189 ypg less than their avg. Aeris Williams had the Bulldogs 1st 100 yd effort for a RB LW, but the Tide is all'g just 72 (2.1) rush ypg in SEC play & held Fournette to just 35 (2.1) LW. Bama is +190 ypg in SEC play, while M&M is -5 ypg. Bama is on a 4-0 overall ATS run. Are the Tide worthy enough to garner our GOY TW?

WKU by 21 over North Texas - WKU remains in control of their own destiny to make it to the CUSA Title game & is +182 ypg in conf play, while NT is -27 ypg. RB Wales is avg 128 rush ypg his L/4 gms & the Mean Green are all'g 247 (4.7) rush ypg away. NT is still ply'g with a shot at becoming bowl elig, so there will be no quit & they're 3-1 as an AD TY.

TROY by 3 over Appalachian St - These are 2 of the remaining 3 undefeated tms left in the SBC, so huge stakes are on the line. Vs 2 mutual foes, Troy is +110 ypg & AST is +69 ypg. AST, however is holding their SBC opp's to 123 ypg below their ssn avg, while Troy is all'g 23 ypg more than their conf foes are avg. The Mountaineers are avg 224 (5.4) rush ypg, but the Trojans are all'g just 91 (2.8) rush ypg in conf play. The visitor has covered both prior mtgs & AST is 11-2 ATS away. Despite those technical edges favoring AST, we feel the HT gets the win.

Auburn by 17 over GEORGIA - Aub survived a scare LW vs Vandy as QB White was inj. He was able to return. Making matters worse however, is RB Pettway was also inj during a breakaway run for the EZ & his inj appears more severe. UGA meanwhile, had all they could handle with KY. The Tigers are in control of their own destiny in reaching the SEC Title gm & have an FCS foe on deck. Against 2 mutual foes UGA is -16 ppg & +68 ypg,

while Aub is +9 ppg & +15 ypg. Kerryon Johnson was the st'g RB to start the ssn & he ret'd from inj 2 gms ago, but didn't have the same type of impact that Pettway has had (1st Aub RB s/Bo w/4 straight gms of 150+ yds). UGA is 2-9-1 as a dog, while Aub is 3-0 as an AF. The Tigers had covered 5 straight before LW & we are not afraid to back them again TW.

WISCONSIN by 28 over Illinois - IL is off an emotional, yet misleading win over MSU while UW is brimming with confidence after finishing their 6 gm gauntlet 4-2. The Badgers are just +13 ypg in B10 play, but their D has held their conf counterparts to 108 ypg below their ssn avg. IL is -132 ypg in B10 action & are being held to 82 ypg less than their ssn avg in conf play. Corey Clement is avg 122 rush ypg the L/4 & the Illini are all'g 209 (4.3) rush ypg in the B10. IL is also -202 ypg away. UW is 19-10 ATS at home & this is HC wknd, while IL is 6-13 as an AD.

TENNESSEE by 17 over Kentucky - This matchup gave us our GOY winner in '86! KY had won 5 of 6, but is off an emotional loss to UGA, where a win would've placed them tied for 1st in the SEC standings. UT got some much needed confidence restored vs an FCS foe LW as new st'g RB Kelly ran for 104 despite just 7 carries & Dobbs threw just 1 incompletion on 13 att's. Now the Vol's have a solid chance at making the SEC Title gm as they just need Fla to lose (still have to play LSU), while winning out themselves (just MO & VU on deck). Since having their 26 gm series win streak snapped in '11, UT is 4-0 SU/ATS, winning by 24.5 ppg. Could we again go with the Vol's as our GOY?

FLORIDA by 21 over South Carolina - SC HC Muschamp returning to the campus that fired him & he recruited the majority of the players on the Gators sideline. SC has turned their ssn around since naming Jake Bentley the starter (who should also be a HS Senior TY!). He's completing 73% w/a 6-0 ratio, but that has come vs UMass, a banded up Tenn D & an even more banded up Mizzou D & UF has our #2 ranked pass eff D. Not to mention its his 1st car start on the road. In SEC play SC is all'g 42 ypg less than their opp's avg, while UF is all'g 91 ypg less. SC is 1-2 as an AD, but they haven't travelled in 7 wks, while UF is ply'g their only HG in a 6 wk span & is 2-0 as a SEC HF TY. Bentley will realize life in the SEC as a QB is tough & the Gators make a statement against their former HC.

Lsu by 10 over ARKANSAS - While LSU showed great improvement under interim HC Orgeron, they still couldn't get past nemesis Bama, while Ark has alternated W's & L's their L/7 gms and pulled no punches in dominating UF LW. It's been hit or miss for Rawleigh Williams & as he goes so do the Hogs. After being shut down by his kryptonite LW, Fournette will look to bounce back against an Ark D that is all'g 267 (7.7) rush ypg in conf play. LSU is just 3-8 as an AF, while Ark is 11-5-1 as an SEC dog. Don't look too much into those technical stats, however, as LSU had covered 3 straight before LW & will bounce back here as they easily have the talent edge & are ply'g with revenge.

Stanford by 6 over OREGON - Stan has ply'd our toughest sked, yet is holding their opp's to 99 ypg below their ssn avg. This is an upset driven series w/5 outright upsets the L7Y. With the return of a healthy RB McCaffrey, Stan is avg 301 (6.0) rush ypg their L/2, while UO is all'g 273 (6.1) rush ypg in P12 play. The Cardinal is -26 ypg in P12 action, but the Ducks are -134 ypg. Stan is 20-11 as an AF, while UO is 1-7-1 ATS TY and with a loss are not bowling for the 1st time s/04.

† Notre Dame by 17 over Army - This gm is being ply'd in San Antonio, TX. While Army is all'g just 286 ypg a closer look at their sked reveals the weakness of the OFF's they've ply'd. ND meanwhile, has a distinct advantage of having just ply'd the same type of OFF LW vs Navy, so look for improvement to the 320 (5.7) rush yds they all'd LW. One more loss for ND & they will be staying home for the holidays, while Army needs to win 2 of their L/3 in order to become elig. Army all'd a ssn high 444 yds LW & exherated a lot of energy in trying to remain alive for the Commander-In-Chief Trophy vs their rival & may re-set their ssn high all'd here. Army is 9-4 as a dog & 10-1 ATS in the state of Texas, but the Irish will win by over 2 td's.

OLD DOMINION by 10 over Southern Miss - Each tm is trending in opposite directions as ODU has won 5 of 6, while SM has lost 3 of 4. The Monarchs became bowl elig for the 1st time LW, while SM is still in need of 1 more win. The RB Lawry ran for 209 (7.7) LW & is facing a SM rush D that has all'd 2 of their L/4 foes 300+ yds (& LSU's not 1 of them). In CUSA action however, SM is +162 ypg, while ODU is +48 ypg. The Golden Eagles did lose QB Mullens to inj in the 3Q LW (CS) & bkp Adamson compl just 48%. ODU does rate just #83 in our pass eff D rankings. ODU is on a 6-0 ATS run at home, but SM is 11-5 ATS away.

We are however, puzzled to see the Middies as a HD here. After not being a HD the L2Y, this will be their 3rd time in that role TY. They're 2-0, including giving us an outright upset winner as our Underdog POY 3 wks ago (Memphis) on these pages & scored an outright upset over #6 (at the time) Houston! Navy is 24-12 as a dog, 9-2 ATS at home, while TU didn't cover in their lone gm as an AF vs lowly Fresno ST TY. We'll gladly take the points & make this our 'Underdog POW!' **FORECAST: NAVY by 6**

MICHIGAN ST by 7 over Rutgers - Since being shutout in B2B gms vs B10 powers OSU & UM, RU is 2-1 ATS & outg'd IL in their lone ATS loss. MSU couldn't follow up their A game effort vs UM as they lost to lowly IL (although did have a 490-304 yd edge), officially removing them from bowl elig. Each are in search of their 1st B10 win! Sparty is however, +21 ypg in B10 play, while RU is -211 ypg. RU is 2-5 as an AD, while MSU is 0-4 as a HF TY and has been outright upset 6 times TY! There will be no outright upset here as MSU is clearly the more talented team & will look to take out their ssn long frustrations here.

Miami, FL by 17 over VIRGINIA - UVA was officially eliminated from bowl elig LW at WF, while UM snapped a 4 gm slide w/a dominating win over Pitt. QB Kaaya was able to stay on his feet & compl 68% w/a 4-0 ratio & TW he will look across at our #112 ranked pass eff D. The 'Hoos are 4-1-1 ATS in this series & there's been 7 outright upsets the L/12Y, but UM HC Richt is 91-45-2 ATS in SU wins & the Canes follow up their statement win LW with another one TW.

LOUISIANA TECH by 14 over Utsa - Just 1 gm separate these 2 in the CUSA West standings, but when comparing results vs middle tier CUSA foes (NT & UTEP) LT is +81 ypg, while Utsa is -5 ypg. The Roadrunners have been a great DD dog, not only covering all 3, but winning 2 outright! LT QB Higgins has a 30-4 ratio & Utsa rates as our #71 pass eff D. Utsa is 4-0 ATS in the series, but LT is 8-3 ATS at home, however is ply'g an 11 straight wk (bye on deck). We can't go against a Roadrunner team that is again getting DD's.

Idaho by 13 over TEXAS ST - Following their upset win at ULL LW, ID is 1 win away from becoming bowl elig, while TXSt is 1 of the worst tms in all of the FBS. The Vandals are -12 ypg in SBC play, but the Bobcats are -175 ypg. Whichever way ID wants to go in terms of OFF is ok, as TXSt is just as bad stopping the run (258, 5.3 rush ypg all'd in SBC) as the pass (#126 in our pass eff D rankings). WASHINGTON by 15 over Usc - College Gameday will be on hand & UW must win to maintain their spot in the playoffs. After losing 3 of 4 to open the ssn, USC appeared done, but all they've done since is win 5 straight, covering 4. In their lone non cover, they outg'd Colorado by 168 yds & were -3 TO's. UW may have been upset at the initial CFB playoff rankings and took it out on Cal LW, finishing w/a ssn high in yds & holding the Bears to a ssn low. QB Browning is in the Heisman race w/a sensational 34-3 ratio & RB Gaskins was held to under 100 yds for the 1st time s/Sept LW (did have Coleman top 100). USC counters w/a QB in Darnold who took over wk 4 & has a 20-4 ratio while RB Jones has ran for 197 ypg (10.4) his L/2 gms. In P12 play UW is all'g 66 ypg less than their opp's avg, while USC is all'g 62 ypg less. The Trojans have our #41 ranked pass eff D, while the Huskie rate our #20. UW is 7-2 ATS in this series & is 18-10 as a HF, while USC is 6-17 ATS away.

Utep by 1 over FLORIDA ATLANTIC - Not only did FAU pick up their 1st FBS win of the ssn LW, they also set a schl rec w/657 yds & RB Singletary also set a schl rec w/252 rush yds (might have something to do with Rice). UTEP has a fine RB themselves in Aaron Jones & he has 2 gms of 200+ yds TY. This could come down to a battle of rush D's & UTEP is all'g 213 (5.7) in CUSA action, while the Owls allow 204 (4.5). Overall on D, the Miners are holding their CUSA foes to 7 ypg below their ssn avg, while FAU is all'g 100 ypg more. UTEP is 0-20-1 all-time SU in the eastern time zone, but we feel this is the time that streak ends.

Boise St by 17 over HAWAII - BSt has 1 extra days rest after ply'g last Fri & is 4-0 ATS in this series. RB McNichols reached the 1,000 yd club for the 2nd straight ssn LW & UH is all'g 256 (5.1) rush ypg in MW play. Surprisingly these schls are fairly even as the Broncos are +30 ypg & the Warriors +25 ypg in MW action & when factoring 2 common foes (SJSU, NM) BSt is +21 ppg & +29 ypg, while UH is +5 ppg & +35 ypg. The Broncos are 32-14 as an AF & 9-4 ATS after a Fri gm, but have failed to cover their L/4 gms, while the lone time UH was a HD TY, they pulled the outright upset, winning by 3 td's! UH in must win if its going bowling.

Middle Tennessee by 3 over MARSHALL - MT may have lost more than just their gm vs UTSA LW, but also QB Stockstill went down, which would be a huge blow as he's already the schls car td pass leader despite being just a Soph. Bkp QB Urzua threw 3 int's in relief, but MU rates just our #99 pass eff D & HC Stockstill is an OFF minded cch, so expect improvement from the bkp. The Herd's ssn has been a disaster nearly all ssn as their lone FBS win is against lowly FAU & they were still outg'd. MU is 0-4 ATS at home vs the FBS TY & MT is 4-1 as an AF.

TEXAS by 7 over West Virginia - Texas is 1 win away from becoming bowl elig after having won 3 of 4. They're led by RB Foreman, who has rushed for 100+ in 10 straight gms dating back to LY (1 shy of tying Earl Campbells schl rec) & he's off a schl rec 341 (10.3) outing LW. WV is all'g just 108 (3.3) rush ypg in B12 play, but they did allow BYU 280 (7.0) earlier TY & all'd TCU & KU to each gain 150+. There have been 2 outright upsets in 4 previous mtgs. UT is 5-0 ATS in the state of Texas TY, while WV is 6-13 in conf AG's.

OKLAHOMA by 17 over Baylor - Baylor followed up having their bubble burst by getting whipped in front of their home fans by 40 as their early easy slate of gms does them no good to prepare for their tougher conf gms down the stretch. OU is unbeaten in B12 play & is +166 ypg. RB Mixon is reinstated after his 1 gm susp & BU is all'g 238 (4.4) rush ypg in conf play. While BU is 4-1 ATS in this series, OU is 5-1 ATS vs B12 foes at home & BU is 1-6 ATS away.

NEBRASKA by 14 over Minnesota - Neb QB Armstrong was taken by stretcher in an ambulance to a hospital vs OSU LW, but was released & on the sidelines before the gm ended so could be cleared to play (CS). Minny needs a win to remain in control of their fate in reaching the B10 Title gm (Yes, that's true!), while Neb, despite the same rec, needs to win out & have Wisky lose another. Gophers RB Rodney Smith has 4 straight 100 yd efforts & leads an attack avg 201 (4.5) rush ypg in B10 play, while Neb has all'd 231 (5.8) rush ypg their L/2. There has been 3 straight outright upsets in this series. Neb is 2-9 as a HF vs B10 foes, while Minny is 9-4 as an AD.

GEORGIA ST by 10 over Uim - GSt got the return of QB Manning LW & he's a big improvement at the position as the Panthers are off a misleading final. ULM is down to their bkp QB Caleb Evans, but he made his 3rd start the charm, leading the win, keeping the Warhawks (slim) bowl hopes alive. ULM is +10 ypg, while GSt is +2 ypg in SBC play, but the Warhawks are all'g 59 ypg more than their conf foes avg, while the Panthers are all'g 44 ypg less. ULM has our #107 ranked pass eff D, so look for Manning to improve his numbers here. ULM is 4-10 ATS vs SBC, while GSt is 10-2 vs SBC foes, but the Panthers don't have the firepower to win this gm by DD's.

MISSOURI by 3 over Vanderbilt - Vandy is still ply'g w/bowl hopes in mind & have Aub all they could handle LW, while Mizzou has had a ssn to forget as inj's have decimated a usual prideful Defense. After all'g just 302 ypg LY, the Tigers are all'g 469 TY. In SEC play they're all'g 160 ypg more than their foes avg, while VU is holding their conf counterparts to 73 ypg less than their avg. The positive for MO is QB Lock has a solid 19-8 ratio & VU has our #61 ranked pass eff D. VU is 3-1 ATS in the series & the visitor is also 3-1 ATS.

MEMPHIS by 1 over Usc - Navy HC Niumatalolo called USF the fastest tm he's ever seen while at the academy & the Bulls need to win to keep pace with Temple in an attempt to reach the AAC Title gm. Memphis all'd Tulsa 362 (637) rush 2 wks ago, but then shut down SMU on the ground LW, however USF features QB Flowers & RB Mack, who can both break free at any time. USF is +26 ypg in AAC play, while Memphis is -26 ypg. They both ply'd Temple & while USF lost by 16 & Memphis won by 7, the Bulls were outg'd by 176 yds & the Tigers by 208. USF is fresh off a bye, while Memphis is ply'g a 9th straight gm. USF is 13-7 ATS away, while Memphis is on a 1-5 overall ATS run.

Michigan by 17 over IOWA - What little hopes Iowa had in reaching B2B B10 Champ gms went down the drain following their lackluster perf LW at PSU, while UM, despite not needing any style pts, crushed MD by 56 pts & had a 293 yd edge. In B10 play, UM is +299 ypg, while IO is -98 ypg. The Wolves did get the luxury of ply'g PSU at home & when they were down their top 5 LB's. UM features a 3 headed monster at RB as Smith, Evans & Higdon have all reached 100 yds in a gm & IO is fresh off all'g a ssn high 359 (6.9) rush yds. UM is 5-12 as an AF & we feel the pink painted walls will soften the Wolves up just enough to keep the Hawkeyes within the number.

HOUSTON by 27 over Tulane - Hou off a much needed bye, while TU enters having lost 4 straight & 1 more loss will eliminate them from bowl elig. Both ply'd UCF in their last gms & while UH only won by a td, they were +203 yds, while TU lost by 31, despite being +51 yds. UH has defended the option once TY vs Navy & all'd 306 (4.9) & UT is avg 254 (5.1) in AAC play. UH QB Ward is compl 69% of his throws & the Green Wave have our #53 ranked pass eff D. TU is 9-17 as a dog.

UTAH ST by 3 over New Mexico - UTSt HC Wells has done well defending the NM option, limiting the Lobos to 179 (3.8) rush ypg in 3 gms. Earlier TY vs AF, the Aggies all'd just 213 (4.1). UTSt was shredded the L/2 gms (all'd 333.5 ypg, 6.5) vs 2 of the top RB's in the nation (Pumphrey & Hill). NM became bowl elig LW & is avg 359 (6.7) rush ypg, but may need to rely more on QB Apodaca, who is 14-18-12-1-0 his L/2 gms. UTSt QB Myers was inj LW (CS). UTSt is just #99 in our pass eff D rankings. UTSt is 22-11 ATS vs MW foes, but NM is 12-6 as an AD.

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 15TH

Ohio at CENTRAL MICHIGAN - OU is in the drivers seat to make it to the MAC Champ gm, while CM is in jeopardy of finishing with a losing record for the 1st time s/11. The Chips missed leading rusher Spalding LW (CS). Despite their records, OU is -7 ypg in MACtion, while CM is just -18 ypg. CM is 3-10 as a HD, but 12-5 ATS off a SU loss, while OU is 2-0 as an AF TY.

Kent St at BOWLING GREEN - Both enter off mtgs the prior Tues that were not complete when this issue was release. Prior to their gm at Akron BG was -45 ypg in MACtion, while Kent, prior to their gm vs WM was +3 ypg. BG's D was all'g their conf foes 20 ypg more than their ssn avg, while the Golden Flashes were holding theirs to 56 ypg less than their avg.

3★ Green Bay over TENNESSEE - Following a shootout in SD that featured 88 total points (3★ LP Winner on the OVER 46'), the Titans (8 pt loss to the Chargers) return to Nashville for their only HG in the entire month of Nov where they've had issues when listed as a dog with just a 3-14 ATS mark. The Packers meanwhile come in on quite the skid following their 3rd loss in a 4 wk span LW at home against the Colts (GB 405-355 yd edge). While GB has certainly struggled as of late, they are still well within reach of the front-running Vikings atop the NFC North (just a gm back). With the Titans lack of success lately in regards to the spread (4-13 ATS run), we'll lean with the visitor this weekend. **FORECAST: GREEN BAY by 7**

OTHER SELECTION

2★ Minnesota over WASHINGTON - Following a dominating beginning to the ssn where they won and covered each of their 1st 5 contests (11 pt avg MOV), the Vikings have now dropped each of their L/3 since returning from their bye including an OT home defeat last weekend against the Lions. While the Redskins have done well recently with a 4-1-1 SU/5-1 ATS mark against mostly subpar opponents, their true identity will soon be discovered with a pair of home matchups against the NFC North's elite (GB on deck) followed by 3 straight road trips to DAL, ARZ & PHI. With a 23-7 ATS mark overall, we'll continue to back the Vikings as their defense (#3 NFL at 299 ypg, #2 NFL at 15.8 ppg) is just too talented to bet against as they look to get back on track. **FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 3**

OTHER GAMES

Cleveland at BALTIMORE - Thursday - Following their 9th consec loss (12th overall dating back to LY, franchise record) to start the ssn LW at home against the Cowboys where they were gashed for 35 pts & 423 yds, the Browns (all'd 25+ pts in each of their 9 contests) head to BAL to take on a Ravens tm that has come out victorious in 15 of their past 17 meetings (9 pt avg win) including a come-from-behind effort earlier in the year (trailed by 18 in the 2Q). The Ravens meanwhile got back on track following their bye wk as they held PIT scoreless for the 1st 3 quarters in the 7 pt win while moving into a 1st place tie in the AFC North in the process. Although it's easy to lean with BAL for the straight up victory here, it's hard to take either team with the spread recently as they've combined for just a 3-10 ATS mark over the L/7 wks. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk.**

Houston by 3 over JACKSONVILLE - Despite a handful of chances LW in Arrowhead against the Chiefs where they absolutely dominated the stat sheet (25-11 FD & 449-231 yd edges) but were done in by 4 TO's, the Jags now welcome a HOJ squad fresh off their bye week and carrying recent success inside of the AFC South with a 9-2 ATS run. While the Texans do have an unusual trip to Mexico on deck for MNF against the Raiders and have had their share of struggles away from home so far in '16 (28-7 avg loss, just 256 ypg of offense), the Jaguars (only home matchup in a 5-wk span) are too hard to trust with just a 6-13 ATS as a HD.

CAROLINA by 3 over Kansas City - After a successful road trip to Los Angeles where the Panthers earned their 2nd consec win despite a 339-244 yd deficit, they now square off with a red-hot Chiefs squad who has rattled off 4 straight victories of their own following a 5 pt win over the Jaguars in Arrowhead where they were surprisingly dominated statistically (25-11 FD & 449-231 yd deficits, +4 TO's) with bkp QB Foles under center for the inj'd Smith (CS vs CAR). While the Panthers do have an impressive 15-6 ATS mark as a HF, we cannot justify giving the Chiefs more than a FG in this showdown in Charlotte as Andy Reid and company have proven to be a dangerous group as the end of the ssn approaches.

NEW ORLEANS by 3 over Denver - Following an easy 3★ Newsletter winner last week against the 49ers where they recorded 41 pts & 571 yds while moving their spread run to 10-3 ATS, the Saints return to the Superdome to take on a DEN squad that surprisingly struggled a wk ago in OAK with the Raiders finishing with a massive 30-13 FD edge along with 218 yds on the ground (DEN had all'd 117 ypg rush coming in). While the Broncos are on a 14-6 ATS run against NFC opponents, they may struggle here as the Saints have come out victorious against CAR & SEA over the past month while avg 33 ppg & 470 ypg so far TY in the "Big Easy".

NY JETS by 1 over Los Angeles - Following their 4th consec defeat LW at home against the Panthers (LA 339-244 yd edge), the Rams take the long journey across country for an early 10am PST kickoff against the Jets. Things haven't gone exactly as planned for the Jets thus far in '16 either as they came into the year as a potential playoff candidate but issues at the QB position and overall poor play has them sitting at just 3-6 following LW's loss in MIA to the Dolphins (MIA GW KR TD w/5:15 remaining, NYJ 330-274 yd edge). With offense expected to be extremely scarce in this one between the NFL's 26th (NYJ 19.2 ppg) and 32nd ranked (LA 16.3 ppg) scoring tms, we'll fade in the direction of the underdog in this one as we just cannot trust laying points with either squad at the moment.

Atlanta by 1 over PHILADELPHIA - The Eagles are in the middle of quite a stretch in their '16 schedule following B2B road trips inside of their DIV against DAL & NYG (443-302 yd edge in 5 pt loss) along with a trip to SEA still on the horizon. They now play host to the red-hot Falcons (only PHI HG in a 4 wk stretch) who pulled out their 2nd consec win LW at Tampa behind a huge outing from QB Ryan (344 yds, 4 TD). While the Eagles have been dynamic at home so far this ssn with a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS mark that includes outright upsets of both PIT (+3) and MIN (+3) by a combined margin, we find it difficult to lean in their direction as the underdog has now covered 10 of the L/11 contests involving the Falcons including 9 outright upset victories.

TAMPA BAY by 3 over Chicago - The Bears return from their weekend off following a much-needed upset victory over the Vikings with QB Cutler back under center (CHI 403-258 yd edge). They now head down South to take on a Bucs tm that moved to just 3-9 ATS after a beatdown last Thur against the Falcons (outgained 461-396) where QB Winston and WR Evans both left w/inj (CS). With both tms scuffling lately as far as covering the spread (CHI 3-10 ATS run, TB just 1-7 ATS as a HF), a FG edge is all we can give in the direction of the home squad in this one.

They now take on a SF team that they've had some solid success against dating back to LY with 3 consec wins by 19 ppg including a 33-21 win a few wks back in Santa Clara. While the 49ers posted 486 yds of tt offense a wk ago against the Saints, 4 TO's and a leaky defense that surrendered 41 pts & 571 yds saw them drop a 7th straight contest (both SU & ATS). With surprising losses TY at home against both the Patriots (w/o Brady) and the Rams, we expect the Cardinals to go all out in this one as they look to chase down the NFC West-leading Seahawks.

Seattle at NEW ENGLAND - SNF - Rematch of the memorable SB XLIX where NE held on 28-24 following a goaline int of QB Wilson. Huge scheduling edge to the Patriots in this one as they return from their wk off sitting atop the AFC with a 7-1 mark incl a 4-0 SU/ATS record since the return of QB Brady to the lineup (16 pt avg MOV over L/4). They now play host to a SEA tm off a short week following their MNF battle w/BUF who has to travel 3,000 miles across country to play under the lights in hostile Foxboro. With the Seahawks having done extremely well when listed as a dog (14-4 ATS), Belichick and company will clearly welcome the challenge with an outstanding 11-2 SU/8-5 ATS mark (29-16 avg score) following their bye week. **Call your VIP Debit Card for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Cincinnati at NY GIANTS - MNF - The Bengals' 2016 campaign hasn't gotten off to the start that they had hoped for as they return from their bye week sitting at just 3-4-1 (tied WAS 2 wks ago in London) and fighting for their AFC playoff lives.
