KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Kansas St over BAYLOR - BU lost st'g QB Russell (OFY) LW & this will be the 2nd straight ssn KSt gets the Bears with a true frosh making his 1st ever start. LY it was PS#3 Stidham, but TY it's PS#24 Zach Smith. KSt is 1 win away from becoming bowl elig, while BU's lack of depth is showing, plus you have to factor in how much the cch's have left, as they know they won't be here next yr & are sending out feelers. The Wildcats are -135 ypg, while the Bears are +28 ypg in B12 play, but KSt led WV 13-0 at the half & ISt 31-10 both on the road so have proven they can be trusted away from Manhattan. KSt is fresh off a bye & HC Snyder is 8-0 ATS in that role so there's no way we can go against him here. Wildcats will get the DD win as the Bears continue their slide. **FORECAST: Kansas St by 10**

3★ COLORADO over Washington St - Wazzu is alone in 1st place in the P12 North standings & CU is alone in 1st place in the South standings! No, that is not a typo! This could be a preview of the Conf Champ gm. While Wazzu is +147 ypg in P12 play, CU is +114 ypg. The Buff's are +328 ypg at home, winning by an avg score of 41-10, while the Cougars had close calls at AZSt & OSt. Wazzu QB Falk will look across at our #3 ranked pass eff D, while RB Phillip Lindsay will look across at a Cougar rush D that is all'g just 123 (4.1) in P12 play. CU is 9-1 as a HF & we feel the Buff's take 1 step closer to their 1st P12 Title game appearance. **FORECAST: COLORADO by 11**

3★ San Diego St over WYOMING - SDSt had already clinched a berth in the MW Title gm into LW, but still went & covered their 4th straight conf gm, which was their 17th straight conf win SU. The nations #1 RB Pumphrey is 347 yds away from becoming the FBS car rush leader & WY all'd 401 (6.3) at UNLV LW! Pumphrey is not alone in the backfield as Rashaad Penny has run for 100+ in 3 of the L/4 gms & had 208 (20.8) LW. The Pokes feature the nations #3 RB in B Hill (1417, 5.7) but likley blew their chance at a MW Title gm after LW's stunning 3OT loss & they're -2 ypg in MW play, while the Aztecs are +222 ypg. SDSt has a huge advantage on rush D, all'g just 78 (2.6) rush ypg in MW play, while the Pokes allow 177 (4.9). SDSt is on the 2nd of B2B AG's, but is 9-3 as an AF. **FORECAST: San Diego St by 21**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ NEBRASKA over Maryland - NU still has a chance at making the B10 Title gm, while MD is 1 win away from becoming bowl elig & has their home finale vs RU on deck. Against 4 common foes (IU, PU, OSU, Minny) the Huskers are -44 ypg, while the Terps are -67 ypg. In B10 play NU is +16 ypg while MD is -113 ypg. NU RB Newby has been held under 100 yds in 4 straight gms & MD is all'g 260 (5.7) rush ypg in conf play. MD QB Hills couldn't finish LW & is a ? here. This is NU's home finale & MD is on their 3rd AG in 4 wks & is 3-8 as a DD dog. **FORECAST: NEBRASKA by 28**

2★ IOWA ST (+) over Texas Tech - TT needs a win to have a shot at bowl eligibility & enter having lost 5 of 6. None perhaps hurt more than LW after missing the PAT that could've sent the gm into OT. ISt snapped a 5 gm slide at lowly KU. The Cyclones are -85 ypg vs B12 foes, while TT is -4 ypg. QB Mahomes is hitting 67% w/a 34-8 ratio & ISt counters with just our #75 ranked pass eff D. ISt is much better at home (+2 ppg) then away (-16 ppg) & the home team is 7-2 ATS in their gms. TT is ply'g an 8th straight wk & 2nd of B2B AG's & they're 0-6 ATS in those. We'll gladly take the points here. **FORECAST: IOWA ST by 3**

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 16TH

Ball St at TOLEDO - Both tms have plenty to play for as UT still has hopes for their 1st MAC Title gm appearance s/'04, while BSt is looking to become bowl elig after a 2Y absence. Rocket QB Woodside is compl 71% w/a sensational 37-6 ratio & should be able to pad his stats more as the Cards have just our #97 ranked pass eff D! UT is +77 ypg in MACtion, while BSt is -70 ypg. This is Sr night for the Rockets, but they're 1-4 as a conf HF & the visitor in this series is 7-1 ATS.

Northern Illinois at EASTERN MICHIGAN - How will EM respond after exerting a ton of energy & becoming bowl elig in their last gm (bye LW) for the 1st time s/'95? NIU is feeling the exact opposite after having their bowl hopes crushed & will be staying home for the 1st time in 9Y! Eagles QB Roback has been on fire avg 367 pass ypg (61%) w/a 9-2 ratio the L/4 gms & matches up well against our #87 ranked pass eff D. Look inside the numbers however, as EM is -29 ypg & -4 ppg in MACtion, while NIU is +58 ypg & +7 ppg! NIU QB Maddie is OFY. EM is on a 7-1 overall ATS run, but NIU is 12-2-1 ATS in reg ssn conf gms.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 17TH

Louisville at HOUSTON - Heisman hopeful QB Jackson set the schl record for most ttl yds in a ssn LW as UL needed a 34 pt 4Q to turn a close gm into a route LW, possibly looking ahead here. While the Cards are #1 in the FBS avg 206 ypg more than their opp's allow, UH is #13X on D, holding their foes to 88 ypg less than their avg. UL in revenge mode after losing LY as DD fav at home, but this is their 3rd AG in 4 wks & ply'g w/playoff pressure (#2, #3 & #4 all lost LW). Cards are 8-4 as an AF, while this is Sr night for UH (Herman's last HG?) & they're 7-0-1 as a dog.

Arkansas St at TROY - The last 2 remaining unbeaten #FunBelt tms battle it out in what could be the de facto SBC Champ gm. Troy is +100 ypg in conf play, while ASt is +58 ypg & all'g 38 ypg less than their conf opp's avg. In the RedWolves lone conf AG, they were held to just 93 (2.3) rush vs GASt & the Trojans are all'g just 91 (2.8) rush ypg in SBC play & 67 (2.1) at home. Troy enters off a previous gm between undefeated SBC members & this is Sr night, while ASt is on the 1st gm of 3 straight away. ASt is 3-1 ATS in the series & the visitor is 4-1 ATS, but the last mtg was in '13. RedWolves are 1-5 as an AD.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 18TH

Memphis at CINCINNATI - UC's OFF continues to struggle & they've been using a QB carousel all yr & ssn opening st'r Moore opened the gm for the 1st time in over a month, but was ineffective, but a switch back to Kiel provided no relief as the 2 comb'd for 45% compl & an 0-2 ratio. UC is -102 in AAC play while all'g 14 ypg more than their opp's avg, while Memphis is -33 ypg in conf play & all'g 57 ypg more than their foes avg. Tiger QB Ferguson has thrown for 300+ in 3 of his L/4 gms, but UC does rate a respectable #42 in our pass eff D rankings. This is UC's Sr night, while Memphis is ply'g a 10th straight wk & 5th AG in 8 wks. UC is 7-1 ATS in the series, but the visitor is 7-2 ATS.

Unlv at BOISE ST - Boise pays a hefty price on the Blue turf as they're 12-26 as a HF incl 0-5 TY, while UNLV has lost by 21, 23 & 19 on the road TY vs UCLA, CM & SDSt. The Rebels kept their bowl chances alive by pulling the outright upset over potential MW Title gm bound WY LW, finishing w/ssn highs in yds & FD's. Both rely on rushing attacks & BSt RB McNichols as rushed for 100+ in 8 of 9 incl 5 straight & UNLV is all'g 175 (4.3) rush ypg in MW play, while Rebel QB Palandech had 157 (9.8) rush LW & Boise is all'g 217 (5.5) rush ypg. Boise is +66 ypg in MW play, while UNLV is -13 ypg. Rebels are 15-7 as an AD.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 19TH

BOSTON COLLEGE by 10 over Connecticut - BC is still alive for a bowl berth, despite entering having lost 4 of 5, while UConn is ply'g for pride, entering having lost 6 of 7. Expect a low scoring affair as both tms struggle on OFF with the Eagles #126 avg 114 ypg less than their opp's allow, while the Huskies are #116 avg 75 ypg less than their foes allow. This is the home finale for BC & they're strong D is holding foes to 92 ypg less than their avg. UConn is fresh off a bye, but are -126 ypg away. BC is 1-4 as a HF, but is 10-0-2 SU in this series.

APPALACHIAN ST by 24 over UIm - ASt's SBC Title dreams took a hit LW, while ULM is still ply'g for bowl elig & QB Evans has now won B2B gms. The Mountaineers are +124 yds in SBC play, holding their foes to 115 ypg below their avg, while the Warhawks are +7 ypg, but all'g 76 ypg more than their SBC opp's avg. This is ASt's home finale, while ULM is travelling for the 4th time in 5 wks incl 2nd of B2B away w/a bye on deck. ASt is just 5-11 as a HF.

Utep by 3 over RICE - Both tms ply'g for pride & off emotional gms. Rice picked up their 1st win over an FBS foe LW, coming back from a 21-0 deficit, while UTEP all'd the GW td w/:25 left to make them 0-21-1 all time in gms ply'd in the Eastern time zone. Miner RB Jones became the schls car leading rusher & is off a 229 (8.5) performance, while Rice is all'g 230 (5.5) rush ypg at home. UTEP is -87 ypg, but holding foes to 17 ypg below their avg in CUSA play, while the Owls are -161 ypg & all'g their conf foes 121 ypg more than their avg. This is the 2nd of B2B AG's for UTEP & they're 3-1-1 as an AD, while Rice is on a 5-9-1 ATS run.

Miami, FI by 10 over NC STATE - NCSt must win 1 more gm to become bowl elig & this is their home finale with a trip to UNC on deck. UM has secured B2B wins after their 4 gm slide & their OL is holding up well for Kaaya, all'g just 2 sks the L/2 gms. Against 2 mutual foes (FSU, ND) NCSt is +81 ypg, while UM is -118 ypg! NCSt has held 4 FBS foes under 100 rush yds incl B2B, while Canes RB Walton has B2B 100 yd efforts. UM is ply'g their 4th AG in 5 wks incl the 2nd of B2B & is 10-6 as an AF. We feel Miami is the stronger team & gets a DD win.

Iowa by 14 over ILLINOIS - IO beat a #2 ranked Michigan w/Harbaugh under center in 1985. Fast fwd 31 yrs & they did it again, this time w/Harbaugh on the sidelines in their emotional win LW. While IO is -81 ypg in B10 play, IL is -149 ypg. The Hawkeyes OFF has struggled their L/3 gms, but against the D's of UW, PSU & UM and now take on an IL D that is all'g 50 ypg more than their conf opp's avg. This is the home finale for IL. IO is 11-1 as an AF.

MINNESOTA by 4 over Northwestern - NW is 1 win away from becoming bowl elig, while UM likley saw their B10 Title hopes end after losing to Nebraska last wk, being held to a ssn low 265 yds. UM RB Smith broke the 1,000 yd barrier, but was held under 100 yds in 4 gms & NW is all'g 150 (3.9) rush ypg in conf play. NW also has a 1,000 yd rusher in Jackson & UM is all'g 123 (3.7) rush ypg in B10 action. NW is +14 ypg, while UM is -4 ypg in conf play. This is the Gophers home finale & they're 10-2 ATS off a reg ssn loss, while the Wildcats are on the 2nd of B2B AG's. NW is 8-3 ATS in this series & the visitor is 11-4 ATS, but we feel the Gophers come out on top.

Wisconsin by 28 over PURDUE - UW controls their own destiny in reaching the B10 Title gm. The Badgers dominate this series, winning 10 in a row (9-1 ATS). When PU hosted 2 similar B10 opp's (IO, PSU) they trailed 42-14 into the 4Q in one & lost by 38 in the other. UW RB Clement is 72 yds shy of 1,000 & should get there TW as the Boilermakers allow 283 (6.4) rush ypg in B10 play. PU is 4-18 (0-4 TY) as a HD, while UW is 5-0 ATS away from home TY.

TEXAS A&M by 26 over Utsa - 1st mtg. Utsa is -39 ypg vs our #128 toughest sked, while A&M is +26 ypg vs our #36 toughest slate. New A&M st'g QB Hubenak has a 4-2 ratio his L/2 gms & Utsa has just our #78 ranked pass eff D (20-7 ratio) so improved confidence should be expected.

While A&M is #109 in the FBS all'g 56 ypg more than their foes avg, Utsa struggles mightily on OFF at #111, avg 70 ypg less than their opp's allow. The Aggies are in an SEC sand-which, while the Roadrunners are on the road a 3rd straight wk & could be just trying to keep their players healthy for a much more winnable gm next wk that would make them bowl elig. A&M is just 8-14-1 as a HF.
