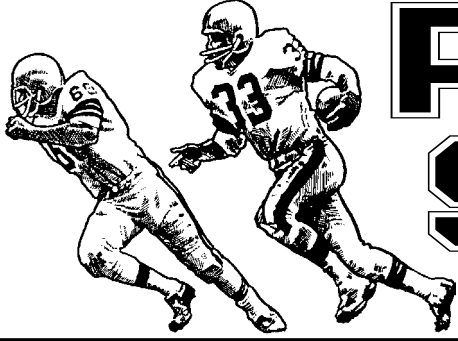

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ KANSAS ST over Kansas** - KU is off a highly emotional win LW snapping numerous B12 losing streaks, but that was at home & now they're on the road. The dichotomy couldn't be more diff as KU is +8 ypg home, but -235 ypg away. KSt is avg 218 (4.9) rush ypg in B12 action while KU is all'g 224 (5.2) rush ypg. The Wildcats use a rotation at RB & LW it was Alex Barnes having his first 100 yd gm effort. KSt has dominated the Governors Cup, winning all 7 mtgs SU/ATS s/HC Snyder returned by an avg of 37 ppg! Also worth noting is KU is 1-8 ATS off a SU win the L6Y & is 13-29-1 ATS away from Lawrence.

**FORECAST: KANSAS ST by 35**

**3★ Arizona St over ARIZONA** - There's not much intrigue in TY's Territorial Cup as AZSt has lost 6 of 7 incl 5 straight, while AZ has lost 8 straight. The Sun Devils, however, can become bowl elig with a win. We've had a ton of success thru the yrs on going with the OVER in this series & both feature extremely weak D's & the Wildcats scored 35 pts on the road at Oregon, which also features a horrible P12 D. The HT is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series & 5 of the L7 have been decided by 7 pts or less, but we feel AZSt gets a double digit win TY as AZ cannot overcome their many inj's as we feel strongly on the side this yr.

**FORECAST: Arizona St by 10**

**3★ FLORIDA ST over Florida** - UF enters off an emotional win in Death Valley & has the SEC Champ gm on deck. FSt is #9 in the FBS on OFF avg 112 ypg more than their opp's allow, but UF is #5 on D, holding their opp's to 123 ypg less than their avg, so it will be interesting how RB Cook & QB Francois fare vs 1 of the SEC's elite D's (however they are banged up). FSt is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in this series, holding UF to 7 pts or less in 4 of the L6Y & while their ssn hasn't ended up the way they expected, finishing with a win & beating both of their in-state rivals heading into the bowl would be a solid consolation prize. The L/2 times FSt ply'd UF & didn't have the ACC Title gm on deck, they won both SU/ATS (\*11 & LY) by 20 ppg.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ NC State (+) over NORTH CAROLINA** - These schls are trending in opposite directions as NC has won 4 of 5, while NCSSt has lost 5 of 6. The Wolfpack, however, do need to win to become bowl elig, while NC can still reach the ACC Title gm with a win & a VT loss. NCSSt is #19 on D holding their opp's to 70 ypg below their avg & NC QB Trubisky barely compl over 50% LW vs the Citadel. The visitor is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series & there's been 12 outright upsets the L/18 mtgs as the dog is 15-3 ATS!

**FORECAST: NORTH CAROLINA by 6**

**2★ IOWA ST (+) over West Virginia** - Ist is brimming with confidence after B2B wins & is much better at home (+23 ypg) than away (-93 ypg). The Cyclones have 3 solid RB's & LW it was Lanning's turn & he had his 1st 100 yd effort & WV has all'd 267 rush ypg their L/2. WV counters with a rush attack that is avg 238 (5.7) ypg in B12 play led by J Crawford, who's off a 331 (13.8!) effort vs OU LW & Ist is all'g 217 (5.2) rush ypg in conf action. The Mountaineers are 0-6 ATS following a SU loss & now must travel after having their B12 bubble burst. We used Ist as a HD last week here as a 2★ & they won outright 66-10 so how could we not go right back to the well this week?

**Lsu at TEXAS A&M** - Despite losing to Bama, there were rumors that LSU interim HC Orgeron could still land the full time job if the Tigers win out, but after LW's home loss this will likely be the final gm for the current ch'g staff. In SEC play, LSU is +120 ypg, while A&M is -55 ypg. Tiger RB Fournette is still limbed (ankle), but Guice has filled in admirably & is just 36 yds short of 1,000 (8.0 ypc!) & the Aggies allow 229 (4.7) rush ypg in conf play. LSU is 5-0 SU/ATS in this series, but is just 4-8 as an AF, however A&M is 4-13-1 ATS at home.

### FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 25TH

**BOWLING GREEN by 10 over Buffalo** - BG has had a disappointing ssn to say the least, but will be looking to close on a positive w/a chance at 3 straight wins, while UB is trying to avoid being alone in the basement of the MAC East. BG is +10 ypg in MACTion, while UB is -56 ypg, however the Falcons are +75 ypg at home, while the Bulls are -201 ypg away. BG has focused on their rush attack during their win streak avg 319 ypg w/RB Coppet having 100+ in each & UB is all'g 245 (5.1) rush ypg in conf play. Despite many advantages leaning BG's way, we feel UB keeps it a tad closer than expected as the Falcons are 0-4 as a HF (0-3 TY).

**WESTERN MICHIGAN by 10 over Toledo** - This gm has huge implications as this is the 'de facto' MAC West Championship with the winner advancing to the MAC Champ in Detroit next wk. Each has 1,000 yd rushers w/WM featuring Franklin (1228, 5.5) & UT's Hunt (1155, 5.3) & dynamic QB's w/WM's Terrell (2,895, 71%, 27-1) & UT's Woodside (3,653, 70%, 40-7). The Rockets have performed well away (+142 ypg), while WM has the edge on D, holding their conf opp's to 37 ypg below their avg. WM is on a 26-11 ATS run in the reg ssn. Row the Boat.

**Northern Illinois by 10 over KENT ST** - Both schls ply'g for pride as KSt enters having lost 4 of 5, while NIU has won 3 of 4. The Golden Flashes have been hit hard by inj's & they're -64 ypg in MACTion while the Huskies are +51 ypg. KSt HC Haynes is likely on the hot seat & this is the home finale so expect an inspired effort. KSt avg 224 rush ypg the 2 gms prior 2 LW & NIU is all'g 226 (4.5) rush ypg away. NIU is 6-2 ATS in this series & the visitor is 3-1-1 ATS.

**IOWA by 4 over Nebraska** - NU still has a shot at reaching the B10 Title gm. There's a disparity in conf play as NU is +39 ypg, while IO is -52 ypg, however the Hawkeyes upset Michigan in their last home gm & the Huskers are -56 ypg away (+120 home). NU QB

Armstrong DNP LW (Hamstring, CS), but that was vs lowly MD & should be able to return here. The visitor is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS w/2 outright upsets the L3Y, but we feel IO gets the job done by just over a fg here.

**Arkansas by 1 over MISSOURI** - Ark has alternated W's & L's their L/9 gms, so a loss should be expected here, right? Not really, as MO enters having lost 6 of 7 as they're D has been decimated by inj's & in the Tigers L/7 gms, are all'g their foes 154 ypg more than their avg! Ark meanwhile, has all'd 3 of their L/4 foes 151 ypg more than their avg! Ark is -63 ypg in SEC play & MO is actually (slightly) better at -61 ypg, however the Hogs do play a tougher sked in the SEC West. Ark is 0-3 as an AF (1st time TY), while MO is 11-6 ATS off a SU loss.

**TULSA by 28 over Cincinnati** - These schls are trending in opposite directions as TU has won 4 of 5, while UC has lost 6 of 7 incl 4 straight. TU has a huge edge on OFF as they're #3 in the FBS avg 132 ypg more than their opp's allow. In AAC play TU is +100 ypg, while UC is -100 ypg! The Golden Hurricane feature two 1,000 yd RB's in Flanders & Brewer & the Bearcats allow 202 rush ypg in conf play. UC is 1-6 ATS off a SU loss.

**TEXAS by 1 over TCU** - While nothing is official, this will be HC Strong's final gm after LW's inexcusable loss to KU. Both are in need of a win to become bowl elig, but TCU still has a gm on deck. TX RB Foreman broke the schl rec w/his 12th straight 100 yd rush gm LW (51-250!) & he's 137 yds shy of 2,000 & TCU all'd 334 (7.4) rush LW! The visitor is 3-1 SU/ATS in this series & TCU is 14-6-1 as an AD & we fell this gm goes down to the wire.

**Boise St by 4 over AIR FORCE** - BSt has struggled vs the option attack of AF. In MW play AF is +12 ypg but is all'g their foes 22 ypg more than they avg, while BSt is +68 ypg & holding their foes to 17 ypg below their avg. Since taking over at QB for AF, Worthman has three 100 yd gms incl a car high 215 (7.7) LW & he's a much better runner than Romine was & the Broncos are all'g 213 (5.3) rush ypg in MW play. AF is 4-0 ATS w/2 straight outright upsets in this series & will keep this closer than expected.

**Louisiana Tech by 7 over SOUTHERN MISS** - LT continues to roll along, winners of 7 straight, but has already clinched an appearance in the CUSA Title gm, while SM has lost 5 of 6 incl 3 straight & is in must win mode to become bowl elig. In CUSA play LT is +139 ypg, however SM is just as good at +135 ypg! SM burned the RS on true frosh QB Howard 2 wks ago, so even if Mullens is healthy it will be interesting to see who will be under center. LT is fresh off a bye & is 4-1 ATS & the visitor is 3-1 ATS in this series. LT is also on a 6-0 overall ATS run.

**Houston by 3 over MEMPHIS** - Despite 1 gm separating the two, UM is -16 ypg in AAC play, while UH is +88 ypg. UH is off an emotional win on Nat'l TV LW, basically guaranteeing HC Herman any opening he wants (Texas, LSU) & has lost their L/2 conf AG's outright as a DD fav. The Cougars have been struggling to run the ball of late & hasn't had a 100 yd RB s/wk 2 vs FCS Lamar & UM has all'd 3 of their L/5 foes 362+ rush ypg! UH is 6-0 SU/4-1 ATS in this series, but the dog is 8-4 ATS w/6 outright upsets the L/12 mtgs.

**Washington by 10 over WASHINGTON ST** - The Apple Cup has high stakes TY as this is the de facto P12 North Title gm with the winner advancing to the P12 Champ gm. In P12 play UW is +155 ypg & holding their foes 85 ypg below their avg, while Wazzu is +111 ypg & holding their foes to 25 ypg below their avg. Cougar QB Falk hit under 50% LW vs our #2 ranked pass eff D & now must face our #17 ranked unit. Meanwhile Wazzu counters with our #49 ranked pass eff D & UW QB Browning has a 37-7 ratio. UW is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS & the visitor is 10-6 ATS in this series.

**† Baylor by 6 over Texas Tech** - This gm is being ply'd in Arlington at AT&T Stadium, home of the NFL's Cowboys. Can you say all OFF, no D? TT is #126 on D all'g 112 ypg more than their foes avg, while BU has all'd their L/4 foes an avg of 84 ypg more than their avg. While TT has QB Mahomes, BU counters with our #9 ranked pass eff D & TT struggles to run, while rush D is the Bears weakness. TT has just our #108 ranked pass eff D & new BU QB Smith was showing off his rocket arm in LW's loss. BU is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in this series.

### SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 26TH

**CLEMSON by 21 over South Carolina** - The Palmetto Bowl. SC turned their OFF over to true frosh QB Bentley that should be a HS Sr after losing 4 of their F/6 gms & then won 3 straight vs limited UMass & inj decimated MO & Tenn. When stepping up in class at ply'g on the road at UF, SC was held to just 256 yds & CU is #13 on D all'g 94 ypg less than their opp's avg. Tiger RB Gallman had his 1st 100 yd effort in 5 wks LW & SC is all'g 211 (5.0) rush ypg in SEC play. CU is ply'g w/playoff pressure & has the ACC Title gm on deck. This gm is in Death Valley & SC is -94 ypg away. SC is 6-1 ATS in this series.

**TEMPLE by 27 over East Carolina** - TU needs to win to ensure an appearance in next wks AAC Title gm. The Owls have a large edge on D as they're holding their conf foes to 161 ypg below their ssn avg, while EC is all'g their foes 74 ypg more than their avg! RB Armstead DNP LW (inj), but is day to day & could return here (CS) & EC is all'g 263 (5.7) rush ypg in conf play. TU has large technical edges as they're 5-1 as a HF & on an incredible 10-0 overall ATS run, while EC is 1-5-1 as an AD.

**CONNECTICUT by 6 over Tulane** - The last 2 mtgs these schls have combined for 25 pts & pts could come at a premium once again as CT is #122 on OFF avg 89 ypg less than their opp's allow, while TU is #114 avg 74 ypg less than their foes allow. TU has the edge on D, holding their conf foes to 33 ypg below their avg, while CT is holding their conf foes to 5 ypg below. CT did a respectable job earlier TY vs Navy's option, holding them to 235 rush & only losing by 4. TU is on a 1-4 overall ATS run.

**MARYLAND by 13 over Rutgers** - As bad as MD has looked for the past 3 gms, a win here will get them to a bowl. The Terps s'd true frosh QB Bortenschlager LW in a bit of a surprising move as he became the 2nd true frosh to get ply'g time late in the ssn. RU has ply'd well at times as they were +28 yds vs IO, losing by 7 & just -27 yds at Minny, losing by 2. RU has been shutout 4 times TY & these schls have 1 td between them the L2W! The visitor is 4-0 SU/ATS & there's been 3 outright upsets in this series, but we're going to call this right at the line & wait for the status of QB Hills to be updated.

**PITTSBURGH by 28 over Syracuse** - Pitt followed up their huge upset over Clemson, with an impressive outing over Duke LW, while Syr's once potent OFF has turned dormant since QB Dungey was inj & he remains a ? to return (conc). Pitt RB Conner is just 55 yds short of 1,000 & Syr is avg 243 (5.5) rush ypg in conf play. Pitt is 10-1 SU/12-2 ATS & has won the L/3 at home in this series by 21 ppg & these teams are headed in opposite directions as the reg ssn draws to a close.

**NORTHWESTERN by 17 over Illinois** - NW must win this gm to become bowl elig. IL is losing their gms by an avg of 24.5 ppg TY. IL QB Lunt ply'd the entirety LW but compl less than 50% vs our #40 ranked pass eff D & NW has our #50 ranked unit. NW RB Jackson has 1124 rush yds & IL is all'g 235 (4.7) rush ypg in conf play. NW is 8-5 ATS in this series & IL is 6-14 as an AD.

**INDIANA by 21 over Purdue** - The Old Oaken Bucket is at stake & a win here for IU will get them to a bowl. In B10 play, IU is +29 ypg, while PU is -122 ypg, however the Hoosiers have a tendency to play to their opp's level as they only beat MD & RU by 6 pts each. IU is #22 on OFF avg 77 ypg more than their opp's allow & PU is #123 on D all'g 107 ypg more than their foes avg. RB Redding is 49 yds short of 1,000 & PU is all'g 275 (6.0) rush ypg in B10 play. IU is on an 8-5 ATS run as a fav & we feel will get the job done against a foe they should have no trouble with if they want to indeed take the next step as 1 of the top B10 teams.

**Boston College by 3 over WAKE FOREST** - BC is in must win mode to become bowl elig & also ply'g w/revenge. While both are OFF challenged, BC does have the edge on D as they're #11 in FBS all'g 98 ypg less than their opp's avg. In ACC play, BC is -181 ypg, while WF is -123 ypg. WF was outg'd at home LW by 259 yds. The visitor is 6-3 ATS & there's been 6 outright upsets the L13Y.

**WISCONSIN by 17 over Minnesota** - Paul Bunyon's Axe is at stake. UW is ply'g with playoff pressure & they still must win as a loss could knock them out of the B10 Champ gm. All 3 of UM's losses have been by 7 pts or less, but in B10 play they're -5 ypg, while UW is +56 ypg. This gm will come down to the trenches & UW figures to have the advantage there as that is where they have put an emphasis for years. UW is 20-10 ATS at home vs B10 foes & we feel will hand UM its 1st DD loss.

**MIAMI, FL by 20 over Duke** - It's been an up and down yr for UM as they won 4 straight, lost 4 straight & now have a shot at winning 4 straight to close out the reg ssn, while Duke, despite being in their preferred role as a dog (15-5 ATS), may have been emotionally spent from their Victory Bell win the wk prior to LW as the loss has them on the outside looking in for a bowl bid. UM is +94 ypg at home, while Duke is -103 ypg away. Duke rates just #79 in our pass eff D rankings & that will be a welcome site for Canes QB Kaaya. UM is 10-1 SU/4-1 ATS in this series, winning the L/5 at home by 24 ppg with the closest MOV by 10.

**GEORGIA by 7 over Georgia Tech** - UGA has the clear edge on D as they're #12 in the FBS all'g 95 ypg less than their opp's avg, while GT is all'g 22 ypg more than their foes avg. In their L/2 gms, GT has been outg'd by 91 ypg despite winning both. UGA is all'g just 113 (2.9) rush in SEC play & GT was held to just 199 (6.4) rush yds LW. Nick Chubb is 100 yds shy of 1,000 & GT is all'g 199 (5.4) rush ypg away. UGA is 13-2 SU/10-4-1 ATS in the Governor's Cup & will remember the LTH after losing in OT & seeing the GT players dancing on the 'G' at midfield w/snapped branches from the Hedges.

**VIRGINIA TECH by 21 over Virginia** - UVA would like nothing more to knock VT out of the ACC Title gm in this yrs Commonwealth Cup & with NC ply'g Fri, the stakes will be known heading into this gm. VT is +109 ypg in ACC play & has won their conf gms an avg of 21 ppg, while the Hoos are -70 ypg in conf play, losing by an avg of 14 ppg. VT is 16-1 SU/11-6 ATS in this series & feel they will remain focused & beat a struggling UVA team by 3 td's.

**ALABAMA by 21 over Auburn** - Just 2 wks ago Aub was considered a serious threat to pull the upset here, but then RB Pettway, who was the 1st Tiger s/Bo w/4 straight 150+ rush yd gms, came up lame on a long run & QB White inj his shoulder vs VU & the OFF has been relegated to a cats meow. Both could return here (CS). After narrowly defeating LSU, QB Hurts heard the whispers that he isn't a dual threat & responded w/ car highs in comp, yds & pass td's vs MSU! Bama has the #1 D in the nation & even if Pettway and White play, they aren't 100%. It will be all Tide for the 7th time in the L9Y. Bama is 3-1-1 as a HF TY vs FBS foes & Aub is 8-16 as an AD (1st time TY). Bama has controlled the Iron Bowl, going 4-1 SU/ATS & the HT is 8-4 ATS.

**LOUISVILLE by 17 over Kentucky** - The Governors Cup is at stake. KY's win LW made them bowl elig for the 1st time in 6Y, while the playoff pressure (or not being able to pull a security breach into UH's playbook) took its toll on UL in their loss to UH LW (HC Petrino said they weren't focused, how is that even possible??). On paper, this is a matchup disaster for UK as they're all'g 223 (5.1) rush ypg & UL is avg 255 (6.3) rush ypg. The Cats are -128 ypg away, while the Cards are +302 ypg at home. KY did allow a 24-7 lead at the half slip away LY & while we feel UL will win, we like the Cats to keep it closer than expected as they're 3-1 as an AD, while UL is 18-31 as a HF.

**Ucla by 6 over CALIFORNIA** - Both enter with identical conf & non conf records, but in P12 play UCLA is just -9 ypg & holding their foes to 49 ypg below their avg, while Cal is -66 ypg & all'g 129 ypg more than their opp's avg. Cal is off 4 straight blowout losses, by an avg of 27 ypg, while the Bruins have 2 wins by 21 pts TY & their largest loss was LW vs the hottest tm in the nation not named Bama. The Bruins have our #4 ranked pass eff D, which obviously doesn't bode well for the run challenged Cal OFF. UCLA is 3-1-1 as an AF & Cal is 5-16 as a HD. Surprisingly this is the ssn finale for both as neither are bowl elig.

**UNLV by 4 over Nevada** - After losing leading WR Boyd 2 wks ago, UNLV is now down 3 st'g WR's, so they've relied on a rush attack that is avg 317 (6.5) rush ypg & that just so happens to be the NV weakness, as the Wolf Pack allow 340 (6.7) rush ypg in MW play. The Rebels, however, also struggle stopping the run, all'g 189 (4.6) in conf play & NV RB Butler is off his 1st 100 yd performance in 5 wks & has a great shot at another here. NV is 9-2 SU/7-4 ATS & the visitor is 3-0 SU/ATS in the battle for the Fremont Cannon.

**San Jose St by 7 over FRESNO ST** - LW we mentioned that FST might play inspired after the hiring of Tedford as their new HC & despite losing, had a chance to win but their GW 43 yd fg was blk'd at the end after losing by DD's in each of their 4 prior gms. SJSt has only been outg'd by 22 & 34 yds in their L/2 gms vs 2 of the best in the MW (Boise & AF). The Spartans are -58 ypg in MW play, while FSt is -83 ypg. The Bulldogs may have found something LW after rushing for 214 yds, led by LB turned RB Hokit, who got his 1st carries of the ssn & finished w/97 (5.4) & SJSt is all'g 281 (6.0) rush ypg in MW play. SJSt is 3-1 SU/4-1 ATS in this series & will get the win by a td.

**OLD DOMINION by 18 over Fiu** - ODU can still make a trip to the CUSA Title gm, but must win here & hope for a WKU loss, while FIU gave an inspired effort after it was announced LW that Butch Davis will be their new HC. In CUSA play FIU is +34 ypg & is holding their opp's to 30 ypg below their avg, while ODU is +52 ypg & holding their opp's to 22 ypg below their avg. The Monarchs had their best OFF perf of the ssn LW & RB Lawry is now just 72 yds shy of 1,000 while QB Washington had a ssn high 416 pass yds w/a 5-0 ratio & FIU has just our #93 ranked pass eff D. ODU is 6-0 as a HF.

**Appalachian St by 21 over NEW MEXICO ST** - 1st mtg. NMSt is +3 ypg vs SBC foes, but is all'g 88 ypg more than their conf foes avg, while App St is +145 ypg in SBC play, all'g 102 ypg less than their conf foes avg. The Mountaineers have gone on the SBC road & won by 24 at ULL, 24 at GS & only lost at Troy by 4. App St RB Moore has ran for 100+ in 7 of the L/8 gms & the Aggies allow 227 (5.0) rush ypg. App St is 7-1 as an AF.

**Troy by 35 over TEXAS ST** - After B2B gms vs unbeated SBC opp's, Troy takes a huge step down in competition against easily the worst team in the conf. The question is however, how will the Trojans respond after losing badly after being ranked for the 1st time in schl history. TSt has already lost at home vs avg SBC tms ID & ULL by 33 & 24 pts, while Troy has performed well away, beating ID by 21 & only losing in Death Valley by 6! TSt is 2-5 as a HD, while Troy is 8-2 ATS away.

Double digit outright upsets are in **BOLD** and Charlotte has the lead in that department with THREE.

When thinking about our Underdog Play of the Week on these pages, MSt is always under consideration when they fit the role. HC Dantonio is in his preferred role as a dog (12-2 w/8 outright upsets) & MSt is 3-0 SU/ATS & the visitor is 3-1 SU/ATS in this series. Sparty gets the easy call as our Underdog Play of the Week!

**OREGON ST by 1 Oregon** - 1996 was the last time the Civil War was played with neither going to bowl afterwards! Despite having this gm on deck, both had arguably their best efforts of the ssn LW. In P12 play UO is -90 ypg & all'g their foes 133 ypg more than their avg, while OST is -82 ypg, but all'g just 5 ypg more than their foes avg. The Ducks are -107 ypg away & the Beavers are even in yds home. OST has performed better than their record indicates & at home has beaten Cal & only lost vs UT by 5 & Wazzu by 4. OST is on a 9-4 ATS run, while UO is on a 2-10-1 ATS run.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 14 over Florida Atlantic** - MT's OFF was avg 537 ypg w/QB Stockstill their F/8 gms, but after being inj & OFY were held to a ssn low 369 three wks ago & then 283 in their 1st gm w/Urzua as the str & things appeared bleak. LW however, Urzua hit 26-44-250-4-2 & the Blue Raiders had 471 yds in their win as the pass threat all'd the run gm to get going again & RB Mathers had his 1st 100 yd effort in 3 wks. FAU has had close losses with 4 coming by 6 pts or less. The Owls D however, was shredded LW & they're -80 ypg in CUSA play, all'g 97 ypg more than their opp's avg. MT is 8-0 SU/6-1 ATS in this series.

**COLORADO by 14 over Utah** - CU must win to reach the P12 Champ gm as they passed their pressure test LW, impressively beating Wazzu while UT was likely looking ahead & inexplicably fell to a horrible UO tm at home, getting outgd' by 122 yds. In P12 play CU is +117 ypg & holding their foes to 76 ypg below their opp's avg, while UT is +9 ypg & holding their foes to 5 ypg below. CU has been dominant at home, winning by an avg of 27 ppg, but UT is +76 ypg away (+25 ypg home). CU is 5-0 ATS in this series with all 5 mtgs decided by 7 pts or less, but we feel this is the yr that a double digit win will take place.

**Wku by 21 over MARSHALL** - A WKU win will put them into the CUSA Champ gm & they're fresh off a bye. This has been a ssn to forget for MU as they're -101 ypg in CUSA play while WKU is +201 ypg. WKU RB Wales has rushed for over 1,000 yds & QB White has a 28-5 ratio and MU counters with a rush D that is all'g 211 (4.8) rush ypg in CUSA play & has our #95 ranked pass eff D. MU is on a 1-4 ATS run at home, while WKU is 7-2 ATS off a reg ssn bye. Despite all the edges favoring WKU, we feel MU keeps it slightly closer than expected.

**Navy by 10 over SMU** - SMU must win to become bowl elig, while Navy is in tune up mode as they've already clinched an AAC Title gm appearance next wk. The Middies OFF is continuing its terror in the 2H of the ssn as they put up a ssn high 480 (7.1) rush led by QB Worth who is now over 1,000 & SMU all'd 278 rush LW vs USF & is all'g 205 (4.8) rush ypg in AAC play. Navy is 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS in this series.

**North Texas by 3 over UTEP** - After pulling the upset LW, NT is now a win away from becoming bowl elig. QB Morris gained confidence LW & UTEP our #119 ranked pass eff D. After B2B 200+ yd rush gms, UTEP RB Jones was held to just 75 LW, but NT is all'g 240 (4.8) rush ypg away. NT is -64 ypg vs CUSA foes, while UTEP is -110 ypg. NT is 5-12 ATS away, while UTEP is 11-5-1 ATS at home.

**USF by 14 over Ucf** - A USF win here & a Temple loss will get the Bulls into the AAC Champ gm. USF is just +14 ypg in conf play, but UCF is -94 ypg. USF is #6 in the FBS on OFF avg 117 ypg more than their foes allow as QB Flowers has over 1,000 rush yds to go along with a 22-6 ratio. He may have to rely more on his legs TW however, as UCF has our #10 ranked pass eff D. The Knights are also all'g 185 rush ypg in AAC play. USF is 7-1-1 as a HF.

**UTSA by 10 over Charlotte** - A win here will get UTSA to a bowl for the 1st tm ever, while UC had favorable matchups its L/2 gms, but faltered in each. The Roadrunners were respectable in their loss at A&M LW & are -44 ypg in CUSA play, while UC is -40 ypg. The Roadrunners are -4 ypg home (-91 ypg away) while UC is -100 ypg away, but has won their last 3 SU on the road, all as DD dogs! UTSA is on a 3-1 ATS run at home & CU won't be as fortunate this time on the road.

**STANFORD by 38 over Rice** - Yes, this gm is really happening as we too had to make sure there wasn't a mistake on the sked. After not having a win over an FBS foe in their F/9 gms, Rice has won B2B as their D is all'g just 248 during the winning streak. Stanford's OFF is however now functioning a ssn best as RB McCaffrey is fresh off a 284 rush yd effort & QB Chryst is getting more comfortable & hasn't thrown an int the L/3 gms. Stanford has beaten KSt, USC & OST all by DD's at home, while Rice has lost by 32, 17, 16 & 45 on the road TY. The Cardinal had been 10-2 as a DD fav into TY, but have failed to cover their lone 2 home gms as a DD fav TY, however we feel they get a blowout victory here.

**Arkansas St by 10 over UL LAFAYETTE** - ASt controls its own destiny in becoming the SBC Champ (just Texas St left) as their the lone remaining unbeaten team. In conf play, ASt is +69 ypg & holding their foes to 69 ypg below their avg, while ULL is +44 ypg & holding their foes to 37 ypg below their avg. ULL RB McGuire has fought through an inj

all ssn, but did have 129 (6.8) vs UGA LW. ASt is on a 6-0 ATS run overall & is 12-2 ATS vs the SBC, while ULL is 4-10 as a HD & has rival ULM on deck.

**Tennessee by 10 over VANDERBILT** - There's plenty of motivation left on both sides as UT, despite not ply'g for an SEC Title, likely has a shot at a Sugar Bowl appearance, while a win for VU will get them bowl elig. The Vol's OFF is clicking at the right time as despite ply'g weak D's in KY & MO, they've still gained 184 & 146 yds more than both had been all'g on avg. Their D has been another story however, as inj's have decimated the unit as they all'd a schl rec 740 yds LW! UT is 11-6 as an AF.

**MISSISSIPPI by 4 over Mississippi St** - This yrs Egg Bowl is intriguing in that MSt is already assured of not making it to a bowl, but can also keep Ole Miss out with a win. Both have struggled on D & are about even as the Rebels are all'g SEC foes 40 ypg more than their avg, while the Bulldogs 37 ypg more than their foes avg. Ole Miss had an edge on OFF, but that's no longer the case as QB Kelly is OFY & true frosh Patterson is inconsistent (as expected). MSt is 10-5 ATS as an SEC dog, 7-3 as an AD & 11-7 ATS off a SU loss.

**OHIO ST by 8 over Michigan** - The Game. An OSU win will likely be enough to earn them a playoff spot, while a UM win will get them into the B10 Champ gm, where a win would get them into the playoffs. OSU has dominated of late, winning 11 of 12 incl 4 straight on the scoreboard, but UM is 12-6 ATS. Interestingly, there hasn't been an outright upset the L11Y. OST survived their trip to East Lansing in windy conditions, while UM survived w/o st'g QB Speight as O'Korn struggled hitting just 7-16-59 vs IU. Speight is a ? to return here (CS). OSU is avg 247 (5.5) rush ypg in conf play, while UM is all'g 97 (2.8) in conf play. Under HC Meyer, OSU is on an 8-0 ATS run when the line is single digits (dog or fav), while UM is 5-14 ATS as a single digit dog.

**USC by 21 over Notre Dame** - The biggest ? for USC entering the ssn was their inexp'd DL & they all'd Bama & Stanford to each rush for 240+ in their F/3 gms. Now the unit is exp'd & they've held UO to 85 (avg 231), UW to 17 (avg 209) & Colo to 96 (avg 210)! ND has run for 200+ in each of their L/2 gms, but won't continue that streak here. USC has 3 losses & if they have any chance of getting a playoff spot, need sizeable style points here & if Colorado loses will play for the P12 Title next wk. The Fav in this series is 10-4 ATS & USC is 22-12 as a HF with 4 straight covers.

**South Alabama by 1 over IDAHO** - SA is 1 win away from becoming bowl elig, while ID is fresh off a bye. Interestingly, in the 2 prior mtgs, the visitor has covered each. In SBC play, ID is +42 ypg, while SA is -71 ypg. The OFF challenged Jaguars are -41 ypg away, but have held their own on the SBC road, losing by just 5 at ULL, 10 at Ark St & 7 at ULM. ID is 3-7 as a HF.

**Wyoming by 1 over NEW MEXICO** - A win here by WY will make them the champs of the Mountain Div & send them to the MW Champ game (in a rematch vs SDSt). The Pokes limited the AF option to just 149 (3.8) rush yds & held SDSt powerful rush attack to 178 yds LW (had been avg 333 in conf play!). RB Hill outdualed Pumphrey LW & NM all'd 412 (9.8) rush LW. NM is however, 11-5 SU/12-5 ATS in this series & we feel will keep it close in a game that goes down to the wire.

**SAN DIEGO ST by 13 over Colorado St** - SDSt was due for a letdown spot LW having already clinched an appearance in the MW Champ gm & CSt is off an emotional win that made them bowl elig. On his way to become the FBS car leading rusher, Pumphrey was held under 100 yds LW, but look for a rebound performance here as the Rams are all'g 253 (5.6) rush ypg in MW play. The Aztecs were gashed for a ssn high 205 rush LW & expect HC Long to be sure the D is back to normal as they're all'g just 96 (2.9) rush ypg in MW action & despite CSt avg 229 (5.5), that shouldn't be expected here. SDSt has dominated this series, going 8-1 SU/7-2 ATS.

**BYU by 24 over Utah St** - The Old Wagon Wheel is at stake & BYU has rebounded from 3 early ssn losses by a comb'd 7 pts, to winning 6 of 7. UTSt is looking for a positive to end the ssn as its been a disappointment otherwise. The Aggies are coming off their best FBS rush perf of the ssn, with 396 (7.9) yds, but BYU is all'g just 94 (3.3) rush ypg vs non P5 foes. The visitor is 5-0 ATS in this series & UTSt is on a 6-2 ATS series run, but despite the technical edges, BYU is the much stronger team & we feel will win by over 3 td's.

**HAWAII by 7 over Massachusetts** - 1st mtg. UMass will be treating this like a bowl, while UH has a shot at bowl elig with a win here. After being held under 300 yds of OFF in 3 of their L/4 gms, look for the Rainbow Warriors to break out of their slump as UMass is #113 in the FBS all'g 66 ypg more than their opp's avg. UH QB Brown has been able to find success at times thru the air & should be in line for another solid effort as the Minutemen have just our #118 ranked pass eff D. UH is 0-8 as a HF & UMass will keep this a tad closer than expected.

**4★ DALLAS over Washington - THANKSGIVING DAY:** - The Luxury Liner known as the Cowboys continued to coast through the NFL waters a week ago against the Ravens as a big performance from QB Prescott (301 pass yds, 3 TD) gave DAL their 9th consec SU & ATS win. Ironically, the Cowboys streak actually started against this very same Redskins squad back in Wk 2 as they went into D.C. as a 3' pt dog and came out with a 27-23 victory. WAS meanwhile moved their current spread run to 11-3 ATS following their SNF win over the Packers (515-424 yd edge) a week ago. While the Cowboys have struggled on Thanksgiving in each of the past 2 sns, we have no problem backing them in this one as they attempt to cash a 3rd straight 4★ Newsletter Winner!

**FORECAST: DALLAS by 17**

**3★ HOUSTON over San Diego** - After an unusual MNF matchup pld in Mexico City against the Raiders, the Texans return home to take on a well-rested SD squad who has gone just 3-8 ATS after their bye week. The Chargers still have to be stinging from their previous matchup against the Dolphins as despite 29-17 FD & 379-337 yd edges, 4 ints by QB Rivers including a 60 yd pick-6 with 1:01 remaining saw them blow yet another 4Q lead on the ssn. While SD is a solid 11-5 ATS as an AD, the Texans have been dominating as a HF over the past 2 years with an 8-1-1 ATS mark (avg cover of 8 ppg).

**FORECAST: HOUSTON by 7**

## OTHER SELECTION

**2★ Seattle over TAMPA BAY** - Following their home win LW against the Eagles where they had a 439-308 yd edge (3★ LP Winner) and moved their late ssn (Nov-Jan) regular ssn spread run to 16-5 ATS, the Seahawks head back across country to take on a TB squad that surprisingly came away with the upset win LW in Arrowhead (snapped KC's 5-gm win streak) behind a 331 yd pass outing from QB Winston. With the Bucs posting just an 8-24 ATS mark as a HD and cashing in a victory just once TY in Tampa (36-10 over struggling CHI), we're not afraid of riding with the AF in this matchup.

**FORECAST: SEATTLE by 10**

## OTHER PLAYS

**DETROIT by 4 over Minnesota - THANKSGIVING DAY:** - Huge NFC North implications in this one as the Vikings and Lions square off for a spot atop the division. After a surprising 0-4 skid following their bye week that included a home OT loss to this very same DET squad, the Vikings got back on track LW against the Cardinals (30 pts on just 217 yds of tfl offense). The Lions meanwhile returned from their bye week and delivered the 3★ Newsletter Winner against the Jaguars despite their own offensive struggles (just 284 yds). While MIN is on a very solid 18-6 ATS run, Thanksgiving Day has been magical for the Lions over the past 3 sns with an avg cover of nearly 21 ppg.

**Pittsburgh at INDIANAPOLIS - THANKSGIVING DAY:** - After a bit of a scheduling reprieve a wk ago in CLE where the Steelers saw their 4-gm losing skid come to an end behind a huge outing from RB Bell (201 tfl yds) & their defense (209 yds all'd, 8 sks), they now head back on the road for a Thur Night battle in IND who they've come out victorious against in each of the past 2 sns (26 pt avg MOV). The Colts meanwhile held off a late drive by TEN to hold onto the 7 pt win LW to move back to .500 on the ssn. **With both tms clearly needing a win to help bolster their playoff chances, we'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on Wednesday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk.**

**Tennessee by 3 over CHICAGO** - Following a 2H struggle LW in the "Big Apple" against the Giants where they were held scoreless in the final 2 quarters, the Bears return to Soldier Field where they've clearly had their share of struggles over the past 2 yrs with just a 3-9 ATS mark. After avg 33.6 ppg over their previous 6 matchups, the Titans were held to just 17 a week ago in their 7 pt loss to the Colts (late drive by TEN stalled in RZ w/under 3:00 left). With the Bears missing their top receiving threat (WR Jeffery susp) along with a handful of other starters due to inj and TEN heading to bye following this matchup, you can be assured that the Titans will go all out in this one as they attempt take advantage of CHI's 4-11 ATS run.

**BUFFALO by 4 over Jacksonville** - After another rough outing a week ago in DET (held to just 286 tfl yds) where the Jags saw their current spread skid move to 4-12 ATS, they're back on the road for the 4th time in 5 wks to take on a BUF squad that delivered the outright upset (+2) a week ago in CIN behind a solid defensive effort (all'd just 12 pts & 300 yds). While the Bills are a solid 5-1 ATS as a HF, we're concerned about laying too much in this one as JAX has frequently delivered late garbage points (83 pts in 4Q TY) throughout a good portion of '16.

**BALTIMORE by 7 over Cincinnati** - Following an unsuccessful outing LW in Dallas (10 pt loss, outgained 417-369), the Ravens return home to take on a Bengals team that they've clearly struggled against over the previous 2 sns with an 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS mark (6 pt avg loss). The Bengals have clearly fallen on hard times so far in '16 after another loss LW at home against the Bills where they were held to a ssn-low 12 pts (CIN has made the playoffs in each of the L/5 sns). While we find it difficult to back either team with a combined 6-14 ATS mark in '16, we'll give the Ravens the edge in this matchup as CIN could potentially be without 2 of their top offensive targets in WR Green (? hamstring) and RB Bernard (OFY w/ACL).

**ATLANTA by 1 over Arizona** - Following another tough outing LW that saw them drop their 3rd meeting away from home this ssn (ARZ 290-217 yd edge), the Cardinals head to ATL to take on a well-rested Falcons squad that was surprisingly held to 126 yds under their ssn avg the week prior in their 11 pt loss at PHI. While the Falcons have covered 4 of their past 5 following their bye week, they are on just a 3-14 ATS run as a favorite which should allow the Cardinals (26-13 ATS vs NDIV foes) to stay within the line in this one.

**MIAMI by 10 over San Francisco** - After a 2-gm SoCal road trip that saw them deliver a pair of victories against the Chargers and Rams (14 unanswered pts in 4Q for the comeback win), the Dolphins return home carrying a 5-gm winning streak to get back into the AFC Playoff picture. **NY Giants by 13 over CLEVELAND** - The Browns' struggles continued a week ago in "The Factory of Sadness" against the Steelers as they moved their franchise-record losing skid to 0-11 thanks to another offensive struggle where they were held to just 9 pts & 209 yds (QB Kessler lost w/concussion, CS). The Giants meanwhile come in sitting at 7-3 on the ssn following their 5th consec win LW over the Bears (held CHI scoreless in 2H). While the Browns can clearly use their
