New Mexico led San Jose St 41-20 in the 4Q but San Jose rallied for 2 TD's to get to 41-34. NM drove 79/6 for a TD to get back ahead of the spread with 2:54 left but SJ went 75/8 and got a 14 yd TD pass with :31 left for the cover...Pitt opened -15' and was -16 most of the week and did finish -17 at some spots. For those that played Pitt early they caught a break. Pitt did lead 27-0 but it was 30-27 when Pitt got a 54 yard TD pass with 1:04 left to clinch the win 37-27. On the last play Pitt got a 33 yard IR TD to win by 16 but did not attempt the extra point so those that played Pitt -16' or more still lost...Middle Tenn was -16' at North Texas. NT took their first drive 87/17 for a TD but MT was up 23-7 in the 4Q. NT went 51/10 and got a TD with 1:57 left but went for 2 and failed! MT recovered the onside and got a 1 play 46 yard TD run by Mathers and when they made the xp with 1:46 left, they covered...Tennessee recovered a fumble in the end zone and after being -3 or -3' all week appeared to have the cover in hand. Earlier in the game RB Hurd caught an apparent TD pass but while coasting into the end zone he got hit from behind and fumbled for a touchback. Georgia with strong armed QB Eason hit a 47 yard TD pass when the WR surprising got behind the DB's with :10 left. Tenn then hit a Hail Mary on the last play but did not attempt the extra point. Instead of a win it was a push/loss for Vol backers as they lost a point on the exchange of Hail Mary's...Florida was -10 and up by 7 was poised for the cover as their defense was not going to allow any more points. Florida had a first and goal at the 2 and it was close but ruled a few inches short on first down. On 2nd down the left side of the line jumped early (should have been penalty and play blown dead) but a mishandled snap resulted in a fumble that Vandy recovered with 2:40 left and chances of a cover were out the door.

The last mtg was in the '04 Cotton Bowl & the Vols dominated as a dog, winning 38-7 (+4'). This is their 1st reg ssn mtg. The cardiac Vols did it again LW, falling behind UGA 17-0 partly thanks to RB Hurd's casual trot into the EZ that resulted in a jarring hit and fmbld into the EZ. The Vols took a 28-24 lead before crushing their backers' hopes of covering by all'g a 47 yd td pass w/ :10 left. Thanks to 2 pen's that put Tenn in range for a Hail Mary, the Vols pulled off a miracle when WR Jennings pulled down the catch that gave UT the 34-31 (-3') win. A&M is coming off a 24-13 (-18) win at SC. They were w/o SEC sk leader DE Garrett as well as their RT Eluemunor & WR Seals-Jones & led just 14-10 in the 4Q before pulling away. A&M is #13 in the FBS on OFF, avg 138 ypg more than their foes allow. UT is #30 on D, all'g 69 ypg less than their foes avg, however they are still w/o 3 of their top D plyr's. A&M is 5-0 for the 3rd str yr, but after st'g 5-0 the L/2Y, they went 6-10 SU/3-13 ATS. HC Sumlin is 4-10-1 as an SEC fav, while Tenn is 4-0 as an SEC dog. We believe history will repeat itself here as Tenn is a dog in this gm, like their L/mtg & A&M will falter again after fast starts to their ssn, making this our 'Underdog POW'

Georgia by 10 over SOUTH CAROLINA - HC Muschamp was a star LB at UGA but was 1-3 vs his alma mater when he was HC at Florida. The HT is 4-0 SU/ATS in the series. UGA missed a late 28 yd fg their LTH in a 38-35 (-6') loss. LY QB Orth was making his first car st for SCar and hit just 6-17-66 and UGA won 52-20 (-17). The Dawgs are coming off a heartbreaking 34-31 (+3') home loss to Tennessee. UGA led 17-0 in the 2Q but trailed 28-24 late 4Q when they got what appeared to be the GW 47 yd td pass from QB Eason to WR Ridley with 0:10 left but 2 pen's gave UT a chance and they completed a Hail Mary to win the gm. RB Chubb had just 1 carry (CS). SC is off a 24-13 (+18) home loss to A&M. The Gamecocks hung around, tied at HT 7-7 and trailed just 14-10 in the 4Q. SC's Off continues to struggle, ranked #126 in the nation, avg 142 ypg less than their foes allow but did show some improvement LW with a ssn high 378 yds. UGA has only all'd 378 ypg on the ssn. This is UGA's 4th road game in 6 weeks while SC is at home a 2nd str wk with a bye on deck. SC is 7-1 as a HD.

KENTUCKY by 7 over Vanderbilt - UK was 12-6 SU/11-7 ATS coming into LY. UK needed a win for their bowl hopes. The Wildcats were on the road and lost 21-17 (+3'). UK shutout VU in the 2H but after cutting the deficit to 4 with 1:06 left in the 3Q, their last 4 poss ended on a missed 37 yd fg, 2 punts and the end of the game. KY is coming off a respectable loss at Bama, 34-6 (+35'). The Wildcats ply'd w/o QB Barker again and were held to just 161 yds of tfl Off. VU is coming off a 13-6 (+10) home loss to Florida. Vandy was fortunate to have a chance at the end after UF fmbld' on the VU1. The 'Dores Off has struggled again TY, avg just 303 ypg and they are comp'g 51% of their passes. KY's run D has been suspect TY, all'g 205 (4.4) ypg and will have to deal with RB Webb who has 582 (4.9) rush yds this ssn. UK has a bye on deck and most likely put more focus on this game as the Bama gm wasn't winnable. VU is 13-6 as an AD while KY is 15-8 as a HF.

NEVADA by 7 over Fresno St - FSt is 4-2 ATS in this series and the visitor is 8-2 ATS with 5 str covers. NV had won 4 str SU then Fresno won 3 in a row and LY NV went on the road and won 30-16 (-4). In the L/2 wks, NV traveled to opposite sides of the country as they were at Pur then at Haw. The effects were obvious as NV lost 38-17 (+3') and all'd UH to put up a ssn high 566 while also being held to a ssn low 397. NV trailed 38-3 and their 2 td's both came in the 4Q. FSt is coming a 45-20 (+9') loss at UNLV. They trailed just 31-20 late 4Q when UNLV added 2 td's in the final 2:29. For the gm, FSt was outrushed 364-64. NV avg 173 (4.3) rush ypg while FSt's D has been awful vs the run, all'g 330 (5.8) rush ypg vs FBS foes. FSt is 9-8 SU in MW road games but are on a 2-6 run and 1-8 as an AD. NV is 7-3 ATS vs MW foes. This is Fresno's 2nd str road gm.

Washington by 17 over OREGON - UO is an amazing 12-0 SU/ATS in this series. LY the Ducks were just 3-3 and were actually a 3 pt dog to Washington but won 26-20. The normal roles reverse TY as Wash is the AF for the first time vs Ore s/96 and they won that one 33-14 (-6'). Wash is off their biggest win of the Peterson era, beating Stan 44-6 (-3) and giving us another Friday Night Marquee winner. The win gives the Huskies a clear edge in the P12 North and they dominated from the start and led 30-0 in the 3Q. Wash was +211 yds which was the largest ydg deficit handed to Stan s/09 when Harbaugh was their cch. This was Wash's most lopsided victory over a top 10 tm in schl history. The Wash D held RB McCaffrey to just 49 (4.1) rush yds. Despite getting RB Freeman back, UO lost their 3rd str gm LW, 51-33 (-2') at WSU. The Ducks all'd 280 (7.0) rush yds and were outgd'd 651-416 and outFD'd 36-20. While the UO Off is #9 in the FBS, avg 157 ypg more than their opp's have all'd for the ssn, their D is #94 in the FBS, all'g 32 ypg more than their opp's avg TY. For the ssn, Wash avg 441 ypg and is +142 ypg. Their D is ranked #37, holding foes to 37 ypg less than they avg. HC Peterson is 25-15 as an AF going back to his Boise days. Ore hasn't been a HD s/09 and they were 2-0 that year, winning by 33 ppg. HC Helfrich is 4-1 as a dog.

USC by 7 over Colorado - USC is 7-0 SU/4-2 ATS. The HT is 4-0 ATS in this series. LY USC was in a flat spot coming off a Friday night win vs Arizona with Oregon on deck and they played like it. USC trailed 17-3 late 2Q but then scored 24 unanswered pts with a 205-48 yd edge. USC held on to win 27-24 (-18'). The Trojans were in a desperate situation after a 1-3 start but got a big win LW at home vs AZSt, 41-20 (-10). USC led 24-6 when AZSt QB Wilkins was inj'd, essentially ending any hopes the Sun Devils had. CU is coming off yet another impressive win, blowing out Ore St 47-6 (-17'). QB Montez looked good for a 2nd str wk, throwing for 293 and 3 tds. The gm was never in doubt as CU led 37-6 at HT. CU's amazing turnaround has been spearheaded from both sides of the ball as their Off is ranked #13, avg 152 ypg more than their foes allow while their D is #16, holding foes to 98 ypg less than their foes avg. USC's opening sked has been brutal as they have already ply'd Bama, at Stan, at Utah and AZSt but this is CU's 3rd tough road gm in 4 wks (at Mich & at Ore). The Buffs are 5-0 ATS to start the ssn and are 5-2 as an AD while USC is 10-5 as a HF.

Michigan by 28 over RUTGERS - In UM's only trip to Rutgers they lost 26-24 (+1') in '14, having a 56 yd fg bkld then RU ran out the final 3:01. LY RU was off a trip to Camp Randall and playing a 2nd str physical road game and UM won 49-16 (-24). HC Ash's familiarity of the OSU D didn't help LW as RU was absolutely destroyed at OSU, 58-0 (+38). They all'd a ssn high 669 yds while putting up a ssn low 116 yds and they were outFD'd 32-9! UM enters off a hard fought defensive affair vs Wisky as they won 14-7 (-10). It was their 1st win vs a Top10 foe s/09. The gm was tied 7-7 and the Wolves needed a 46 yd td from QB Speight to WR Darboh to take the lead. A spectacular one handed int by DB Lewis sealed the victory. The Wolverines held 349-159 yd & 21-8 FD edges. UM is +196 ypg on the ssn, and their D is #2 in the FBS, holding foes to 215 ypg less than their foes on the ssn! UM is off games vs Penn St and Wisc but has a bye on deck. RU is just 2-7 SU in B10 HG's (5-4 ATS). Mich is 5-11 as an AF, but is 16-8 as a DD fav vs B10 foes. RU is 3-8 ATS overall. This is Mich's 1st road gm of the year.

Marshall by 17 over NORTH TEXAS - LY was their first mtg as FBS foes and MU led 24-0 late 2Q but NT got a 93/9 drive for a garbage td with 1:09 left to only lose 30-13. MU's LTH was in 1988 in the 1st Rnd of the FCS Plyoffs. Marshall is coming 2 str losses to P5 foes incl LW at Pitt, 43-27 (+16'). MU trailed 27-0 at HT as Pitt dominated w/a 386-102 yd edge but MU rallied in the 2H and was down

The Mean Green led 7-0 in the 2Q but was held scoreless in 8 str poss's incl 6 3&O's. They cut the deficit to 23-13 late 4Q when MT added a garbage time td that cost NT backers a cover. NT was outgd'd 477-308 but it was their best def perf of the ssn as they held MT to 64 yds less than they avg for the year. MU was just 4-8 SU on the CUSA road its first 2Y and are 9-4 SU the last 3. NT was 4-2 ATS as a HD but have a brand new HC in Seth Littrell.

Southern Miss by 17 over UTSA - The HT is 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS. LY SM led 26-0 mid 3Q & won 32-10 (-8). LTH ('14) was on a Thurs night & SM (+9) trailed 9-0 into the 4Q but led 10-9 w/UTSA getting a GW 38 yd fg w/:02 left to pull out the 12-10 win. UTSA is fresh off a bye & a 33-19 (+4') loss at ODU the wk prior. They're avg just 96 (2.8) rush ypg, all'g 202 (4.6) rush ypg & are dead last in FBS avg 166 ypg less than their opp's allow. SM is off a 44-28 (-26) home win vs Rice. QB Mullen threw for a car high 591 yds and 4 td's and SM set a schl rec with 702 tfl yds. WR Staggers was 6-292 and also broke the schl rec for rec yds. SM's Off avg 534 ypg on the ssn and is #35 in the FBS, avg 66 ypg more than their opp's allow. The Roadrunners are 4-2 as a HD. SM is playing a 6th str wk. SM had only been an AF 3X the L5Y (all in L2Y covering by an avg of 27 ppg!) & are 16-7 ATS as an AF L11Y.

ULM by 3 over Idaho - The HT is 4-2 SU in this series but the visitor is 5-1 ATS. The teams are 3-3 SU/ATS. LY Idaho got the home upset 27-13 (+1). ID had a commanding 489-243 yd edge. LTH the game was tied at 7, 21 and 31 but ULM got the GW td on a 1 yd run with :09 left. While ID is 1-7 SU on the SBC road they are 7-1 ATS. ULM was trounced LW at Aub 58-7 (+33). The Warhawks were -437 yds & -20 FD's for the gm and their only td came on the final play of the 1H. LW we went against ID for our Revenge POW and we picked up an easy winner as Troy dominated, 34-13 (-14). ID trailed 34-7 and their final td didn't come until the 4Q. ID was outgd'd 530-255 & outFD'd 27-19. ULM is -159 ypg on the ssn while ID is -157 ypg on the ssn. ULM is 7-13 ATS at home and this is their 1st HG since the opener! UTEP by 14 over Flia - The HT is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series. LY FIU dominated the entire gm, leading 42-3 at HT and won 42-12 (-14'). LTH UTEP led 17-7 at HT and went on to win 33-10 (-6'). In their first gm following the firing of HC Turner, FIU beat rival FAU in the 'Shula Bowl', 33-31 (+-4'). There were 5 lead changes in the gm and FIU trailed 24-13 Q, then rallied to take the lead in mid 4Q. FAU had two chances to take the lead back but FIU turned them away both times with 3&O's. FIU held 469-328 yd & 25-17 FD edges. UTEP is coming off a 28-7 (+22) road loss to LT. They trailed 14-0 in the 1Q and didn't get their td until the 4Q. This is the first of B2B road gms for FIU and they are 8-3 in those. UTEP has a bye on deck.

Alabama by 17 over ARKANSAS - Bama is 9-0 SU in this series. LY Ark (+16') had a 7-3 lead at the half (Bama 213-77 yd edge) but Bama scored 24 str before Ark got a td w/1:37 left for the backdoor, 27-14. LTH ('14) Bama entered off an upset loss at Ole Miss & nearly were upset again. They were -128 yds, but got a 4Q comeback & won 14-13 (-9). Ark enters off a 52-10 (-49) win over FCS Alcorn St. Bama didn't quite look like their dominant self LW (but did have a lot of off field-distractions) in their 34-6 (-35') home win vs KY. The gm was tied 3-3 in the 2Q and got a 55 yd fmbld ret to go up 17-3 at HT. Bama held KY to just 161 yds of Off. SAN DIEGO ST by 24 over Unlv - SDSt is 11-3 SU/10-4 ATS. The HT is 11-4 SU/8-7 ATS. SDSt is 7-0 SU/5-2 at home in this series but didn't cover in the L/2. LY we had a 3★ Key Selection in Power Sweep on SDSt on the road and they led 31-0 at HT before winning 52-14 (-16). For the 2nd str ssn, SDSt has rebounded from a bad loss to South Alabama, this time losing on the road 42-24 (-19). The Aztecs led 24-21 in the 4Q but after all'g a 69/11pl td drive, fmbld their next 2 poss's and one was ret'd for a td. UNLV enters off a 45-20 (-9') win vs Fresno St. The Rebels put up 364 (6.7) rush yds led by RB Williams who put up 153 while QB Sneed added 147 (9.8). STANFORD by 17 over Washington St - SU is 8-0 SU/5-3 ATS in this series. They had won the previous 7, all by 7 or more, with the avg win by 26.6 ppg but LY needed WSU to miss a 43 yd fg on the final play to escape with a 30-28 (-10') road win. LW we came away with an easy winner as we went against Stanford on our Friday Night Marquee. In a gm that likely decided the P12 North Title, Stan was blown out 44-6 (+3) at Wash as the Cardinal were completely dominated from the onset, trailing 23-0 at HT. Stan was outgd'd 424-213 & outFD'd 22-14 and the -211 yd deficit was Stan's worst since their '09 bowl gm. Wash ST enters after pulling an outright upset, beating Oregon 51-33 (+2). The Cougars surprisingly dominated Ore on the ground with 280 (7.0) rush yds and 6 td's. WSU seems to be clicking on all cylinders after their 0-2 start as they put up a ssn high 651 yds while holding Ore to a ssn low 416 yds. WSU also held a 36-20 FD edge. While its not surprising to see WSU's Off ranked #12, avg 154 ypg more than their foes have all'd TY, it's shocking to see their D ranked #23, holding foes to 84 ypg less than they avg. Stan avg just 310 ypg this ssn which is 126 ypg less than they avg LY. Stan is 10-5 as a HF but WSU is 13-3 as an AD. Stan is 9-1 off a SU loss. This is a bit of a sandwich gm for Stan as they are off their big gm vs Wash with ND on deck.
