4★ Florida St over DUKE - FSU is 19-0 SU all time in this series and on a 6-0 ATS run with the last meeting taking place in the 2013 ACC Title game. The 'Noles enter off an emotional loss to rival Miami. Duke QB Daniel Jones has struggled recently with just a 2-4 ratio in his L/4 games and FSU has the #7 D, holding foes to 152 ypg below their average. Duke has lost B2B games and 2 weeks ago vs the Canes, were beaten by 25 points. FSU actually held a 69 yard edge vs Miami and lost in the final seconds. Duke has failed to cover 2 straight as ACC dogs and FSU is far more battle tested, having faced Bama, WF, NCSt and Miami.

FORECAST: Florida St by 17

3★ ARMY over Eastern Michigan - Army is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in recent meetings including putting up 50+ points the L/2. EM is playing their 3rd straight road game and is in a MAC sandwich. Army enters full of confidence off a dominating win at Rice. Army has the OFF edge (#63-#108) and is averaging 373 (6.3) rush ypg. While EM is allowing 130 (3.4) rush ypg, a closer look reveals they allowed 4.7 ypc to Charlotte, the most run heavy offense they've faced. The Eagles are more focused on their MAC games and this is a veteran Army squad that runs the option extremely well.

FORECAST: ARMY by 14

3★ Michigan St over MINNESOTA - Minnesota is on a 6-1 ATS run in this series, but this is the first meeting s/13. MSU pulled the outright upset, cashing another 2★ on these pages (now 9-3 TY) in their emotional win over Michigan last week. They're #4 in the FBS on D, holding their foes to 169 ypg below their average, while Minnesota is just #112 on OFF, averaging 60 ypg less than their foes allow on average. The Gophers have allowed just 1 sk & are avg 190 (4.1) rush ypg, but that success has come against foes with a below avg DL. Sparty is on their second of B2B away games, but is 21-12 ATS away from East Lansing, while the Gophers are on a 6-11-1 regular season ATS run.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ SAN DIEGO ST over Boise St - These two L/met in '14 and Boise St has won the L/3 mtgs (2-1 ATS). The Broncos hadn't been a reg ssn-non neutral site dog since '13 but this is their 2nd time in that role already this year! They did return from bye with positive results LW in Provo as their defense held BYU to just 7 pts & 238 yds in the 17 pt victory. The Aztecs had no problem getting past an emotional UNLV squad LW as they easily covered the 9 pts (31 pt win) while delivering a 3★ Newsletter Winner in the process. While the Broncos are a solid 37-18 ATS on the road, the Aztecs get the edge here as they're on a 15-1 SU run at home against the MW (29-13-1 ATS in all conf gms).

2★ Auburn over LSU - LSU is in revenge mode after having appeared to win on the final play only to have it overturned (time ran out) in what became HC Miles' final game last year. LSU has won the L/8 when hosting, while Auburn has covered 4 of the L/5. Last week LSU was also in revenge mode and pulled out a win in the Swamp thanks to a missed PAT. Auburn was crushing Ole Miss at halftime last week then cruised in the 2H, allowing a td with 2:57 left, blowing what earlier seemed like an easy cover and breaking Tiger backer hearts. LSU averages 197 (4.8) rush ypg and Auburn only allows 111 (3.0). Auburn has the edge in all 3 phases and is 6-3 as an AF. LSU is 1-4 as a dog.

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY OCT 11:

South Alabama at TROY - These in-state and SBC rivals play for the 'Battle for the Belt'. Three of the L/4 meetings have been decided by 7 points or less. Troy is on a 3-0-1 ATS series run. LY the Trojans finished with an FBS high 585 yards as QB Silvers threw for a career high 395 (67%) and they scored the GW td w/1:20 left. Each enter fresh off a bye. Silvers is hitting 66% this year, but has just a 2-2 ratio, which should improve considering SA has our #101 pass eff D. Troy is 11-21 as a HF, but SA is 4-11 as an AD.

THURSDAY OCT 12:

Texas St at LOUISIANA - Louisiana is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series, winning by an average of 24 ppg and covering by an avg of 19 ppg. This is the Ragin' Cajuns lone home game in a 7 week stretch, while Texas St is playing a 7th straight week with a bye on deck. These are two of the worst teams in the FBS as they've combined for just 1 win vs an FBS foe, that by Louisiana last week at Idaho despite being held to a season low 297 yards. The Cajuns have the edge on OFF and ST's, while Tx State has the edge on D. Louisiana is 8-11 as a HF including 0-2 TY, while the Bobcats are 4-10 as an AD.

FRIDAY OCT 13:

Clemson at SYRACUSE - It's homecoming in Syracuse. Cuse has dropped all 4 ACC meetings by 27 ppg. Last week Clemson built a 28-0 4Q lead over WF before allowing two 4Q td drives. The Tigers held a 426-198 yard edge before WF added their garbage yards. QB Bryant injured his ankle (CS). Backup Hunter Johnson was the top QB recruit in last year's class and he hit all 5 of his attempts. This will be QB Dungey's stiffest test as the Tigers bring the #3 D into the Carrier Dome and hold foes to 174 ypg below their average. Cuse's D is just #70, while Clemson has the #8 OFF, averaging 133 ypg more than their foes allow. Clemson is 15-10 as an AF and has a bye on deck. Cuse is 1-4 as a HD under Babers.

Washington St at CALIFORNIA - After 5 gms at home to begin the ssn, the Cougs are traveling for a 2nd consec wk and on short rest to boot. In their trip to Eugene a wk ago, WSU was able to hold the Ducks scoreless after the 1Q in the 33-10 victory (369-277 yd edge). The Cal offense was abysmal LW in Seattle totaling just 97 tt yds (only TD came on def fumble ret). With the Bears on quite the tough stretch of matchups that includes Ole Miss, USC & Oregon (Cal 8-16 ATS as a HD), we'll call for the Cougs to continue their perfect start to '17 here as they've covered 7 of their past 8 in Berkeley.

SATURDAY OCT 14:

WISCONSIN by 17 over Purdue - Wisconsin has dominated this series to the tune of 9 straight wins by at least 17 points to go along with a 10-1 ATS run. Badgers true frosh RB Taylor had a car high 249 (10.0) rush yards in wearing down the Black Shirts D and Purdue allowed Minnesota's below average OL to pave the way for 227 (4.8) rush yards last week. Purdue's win wasn't as easy as the final score indicated as they had a 76 yd IR td w/:10 left. Wisconsin is #12 in the FBS on D, holding foes to 110 ypg below their average and when the Boilermakers saw a similar D in Michigan 2 games ago, they were held to season lows in yards (189) and FD's (9). The Badgers are 20-11-1 ATS in B10 home games to go along with their series dominance.

Northwestern by 1 over MARYLAND - This is the first all-time meeting. Maryland is home for the only time in a four game stretch and in an Ohio State/Wisconsin sandwich. They were destroyed by the Bucks last week and lost their third QB to inj (Bortenschlager, CS) getting out-gained 584-66. UNC transfer Caleb Henderson saw his first action of the season, which actually is a good thing as he was the projected starter entering the season before a foot injury in fall camp shut him down. Northwestern was stymied by Penn St as they have QB issues of their own.

COLLEGE MARQUEES - START THIS WEDNESDAY! 4-1 80% LAST WEDNESDAY-SATURDAY!!!

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Sr Matt Alviti saw playing time for the second time this season. NW is 5-10-1 as an AF. We'll lean with the home dog considering Henderson is healthy enough to play.

Miami, Oh by 16 over KENT ST - It's Homecoming in Kent. The home team has won the L/4 meetings (3-1 ATS). Miami was 0-6 when they won last year that propelled them to a 6 game win streak and a bowl. The RedHawks enter off an emotional home loss to Bowling Green as they fumbled when going in for the GW td and had it returned 93 yards for a td the other way. Kent remains one of the worst teams in the nation as their lone win came against an FCS foe and they were held to just 131 yards vs NIU last week. Miami may be without QB Ragland (CS). This is the RedHawks third road game in four weeks, but they'll be an angry bunch and will look to take out their frustrations vs an overmatched Golden Flash squad.

Ohio by 16 over BOWLING GREEN - It's homecoming in Bowling Green. Ohio's win last year last year snapped Bowling Green's four game series win streak. The Bobcats had their 3 game win streak snapped by Central Mich last week, while the Falcons appeared to be on the verge of an 0-6 start but benefitted from a 93 yd fumble return td w/1:21 left to hang on and beat Miami, Oh. Bowling Greens strength on OFF is their run game, which plays right into Ohio's strength and the Falcons are atrocious to say the least on D, ranking #129 in the FBS allowing 187 ypg more than their foes average. Ohio is 8-2 ATS in true road games, while Bowling Green is 1-6 ATS at home.

W MICHIGAN by 13 over Akron - It's Homecoming weekend in Kalamazoo! Western Michigan is 6-1 SU/ATS in MAC meetings, winning by an average of 31 ppg. 1-0 (-12). The Broncos enter off a thrilling TOT win at Buffalo while Akron had its way in their win over a Ball St team without their starting QB. While both teams struggle on D, Western Michigan has an OFF that averages 237 (4.9) rush ypg featuring a 3 headed monster at TB. The Broncos are on a 29-14 regular season ATS run, while the Zips are 14-8 as an AD. We'll lean with the fresher dog.

Toledo by 7 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN - It's Homecoming weekend in Mt. Pleasant. Toledo has won 7 straight meetings by 16 ppg. Toledo had all they could handle in holding off Eastern Michigan while Central pulled the outright upset at Ohio. Chippewas QB Morris was originally at Michigan and has shown some bright spots for the offense. The Rockets are just #112 in the FBS on D, allowing 68 ypg more than their foes average. The Rockets have won their last two games over FBS foes by a combined 8 points and we'll lean with the home dog that has plenty of motivation.

Northern Illinois by 14 over BUFFALO - NIU is 9-0 SU/7-2 ATS in this series, winning by an average of 29 ppg! NIU is 16-5 as an AF, while Buffalo is just 6-11 ATS vs MAC foes but covered last week vs reigning MAC Champ WM in a marathon 7OT (tied NCAA rec) loss. The Bulls were with out starting QB Tyree Jackson, but Drew Anderson threw for a MAC record 597 yards and 7 td's. NIU has a small OFF edge (#89-#96) but a decent D edge (#46-#90) with our #43 pass eff D. UB is playing for their 7th straight week and off a long and tiring loss may not have enough in the tank vs a solid NIU team that underperformed last week.

TEMPLE by 13 over Connecticut - Temple had their first shutout over an FBS school s/11 in last years meeting and is 3-1 ATS in the series as AAC rivals. The Owls enter off their best performance of the season, finishing with 523-287 yard and 24-15 FD edges in their win at East Carolina. Conversely, UConn enters off their worst performance of the season, getting outgained by a season high 234 yards while allowing the most points in school history. The Huskies are #128 in the FBS on D, allowing 186 ypg more than their foes allow and the Owls proved last week they can move the ball when playing a lackluster D. Temple is 6-2 as a HF and on a 24-10 overall ATS run, while UConn is 8-19-1 as an AD and on a 15-38-1 overall run.

Virginia by 1 over NORTH CAROLINA - It's the South's Oldest Rivalry. North Carolina has won the L/7 including all but 1 by double-digits (Avg MOV 19 pts) and is 6-1 ATS. HC Mendenhall has the 'Hoos thinking bowl game with a 4-1 start and QB Benkert has thrown for 286 ypg with a 13-3 ratio including 3 td's in last week's win over Duke. North Carolina has now lost 3 straight and injuries have piled up. UVA brings the #23 D, holding foes to 74 ypg below their average while North Carolina has the #103 D. While HC Fedora is 0-5 as a HD, UVA hasn't been an AF since 2014 so we'll go against the 'Hoos in an unfamiliar role.

ILLINOIS by 4 over Rutgers - Last year was the first meeting as B10 rivals and Illinois won by over 2 td's despite being outFD'd 23-10 as they forced 5 TO's. Rutgers enters fresh off a bye, while the Illini enter off B2B physical losses vs Nebraska and Iowa. Illinois made the switch to Jeff George Jr at QB and despite losing by over 4 td's, they finished with a season high 446 yards. Rutgers also has QB issues as Rescigno has re-appeared after starting the year third on the depth chart, just like last year. There's no indication that Rescigno will start, but if Bolin struggles, he will be inserted. The Illini is 15-26 as a HF, while the Scarlet Knights are 3-7 as an AD.

WEST VIRGINIA by 7 over Texas Tech - It's homecoming weekend in Morgantown and this is their lone home game in a 5 week span. Tx Tech is 4-1 ATS in this series as B12 rivals. This figures to be a high scoring affair. West Virginia's OFF, led by QB Grier, is #4 in the FBS averaging 172 ypg more than their foes allow. Grier just lit up our #8 pass eff D in TCU and now takes a step down in competition as Tx Tech has our #32 pass eff D. The Red Raiders are travelling for the third time in 4 weeks and are on the 2nd of B2B away games. We'll back the Mountaineers by a td over an improving, but road weary Red Raiders squad.

Nc State by 10 over PITTSBURGH - It's homecoming in Pittsburgh. This is the first meeting as ACC rivals. We cashed with NCSt on a rare Thurs night 3★ LPS and the Wolfpack pulled the outright upset over Louisville. QB Finley threw for 367 yards, has a 10-0 ratio, and now opposes just our #105 ranked pass eff D. QB Browne was inj'd last week and is out here, but Dinucci has shown he is more than capable to run the OFF. Pitt is 7-2 ATS vs ACC Atlantic foes while NCSt is 1-7 ATS vs ACC Coastal foes and 0-4 as a favorite this year. We'll lean with Pitt to keep it closer than expected.

Michigan by 10 over INDIANA - It's homecoming weekend in Bloomington. Michigan has won 21 straight in this series. The last time the Hoosiers beat the Wolverines was here in '87. Michigan should be plenty motivated here off a loss to their rival and Harbaugh will have no problem letting his players know that the Hoosiers have scheduled their HC for their visit! The Wolves have held all 5 of their foes to season lows in yards and are #1 in the FBS, allowing 208 ypg less than their foes average. Michigan has the edges at the LOS and Indiana is 1-5 as a regular season dog. The Wolverines will re-gain confidence here before heading to their showdown vs PSU next week.

UCF by 28 over East Carolina - It's homecoming weekend in Orlando. East Carolina is travelling for just the second time in 5 weeks and the visitor is 3-1 ATS in this series. UCF had their game vs Cincy called just before the start of the 4Q, but QB Milton still threw for a career high 5 td's as they ended up with 515 total yards. They're #13 in the FBS on OFF averaging 117 ypg more than their foes allow, while the Pirates allowed Temple a season high 523 yards last week and are #127 in the FBS on D allowing 154 ypg more than their foes average. UCF has a huge game at Navy on deck and with the distractions of homecoming this week we'll lean with the dog who are more than capable of getting a backdoor cover.

Tulane by 16 over FIU - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. While Tulane has played in the state of Florida 3 of the L4Y, going 0-3 SU/1-2 ATS and losing by an average of 18 ppg, this is FIU's only game defending the option and HC Davis lost his last 2 vs GT's option while at UNC. The Green Wave's option is running at an efficient level coming off a season high 488 (7.0) rush in their blowout over Tulsa and their D is #29 in the FBS, holding their foes to 61 ypg below their average. Despite taking on a backup QB, FIU was routed at Middle Tenn as they are among the worst in the nation on both OFF and D. The Panthers are on just a 5-13-2 overall ATS run and are 3-5 as a HD. Sure Tulane is just 13-54 SU away, but they are 2-0 as an AF under HC Fritz and on a 4-1 overall ATS run.

LOUISVILLE by 14 over Boston College - L'Ville has won all 4 ACC meetings by an average of 23 ppg (3-1 ATS). Boston College continues to struggle on OFF as they had just 180 yards until the 4Q vs Va Tech before getting a td that provided a backdoor cover for Eagles' backers. QB Brown continues to struggle with accuracy, but he's faced pass eff D's no worse than #43 in our rankings and L'Ville is just #98. The Cards have outgained foes by 207 ypg, but just 25 ypg vs ACC foes. BC is 13-6-1 ATS away from home. UL is 18-34-1 as a HF and on a 1-9 ATS run. We like BC to keep it closer than expected.

IOWA ST by 14 over Kansas - This is the 97th all-time meeting and these schools have played every year s/32! ISU's win last year snapped their 14 game road losing streak. Speaking of streaks, the 'Clones, despite being w/o starting QB Park (CS) snapped an 18 game series losing streak and a 20 game losing streak against ranked foes after winning their first road game ever over a Top 5 team in their monumental outright upset over OU last week (free winner on Button 9 comp line Thurs!). QB Kempt, who had just 2 career attempts entering the game hit 18-24-343-3-0. That should make their heads swell a bit especially considering a KU squad that has lost 42 straight true road games. We're going to back the Jayhawks as could another streak be coming to an end?

Tcu by 6 over KANSAS ST - TCU will be in revenge mode after looking lifeless in last years home loss when they were held to a season low in yards and FD's. The Horned Frogs are the lone undefeated B12 team. They appeared in control up 17-3 late 3Q vs West Virginia LW, but 2 coverage breakdowns resulted in allowing 2 td's in a span of about 2.5 minutes and they failed to cover, dropping our 4★ on these pages. Cats backers had to sweat it out in their loss at Texas LW as QB Ertz was inj 3Q (CS) killing their pass game, allowed the game tying fg w/1:37 left, and fell by 6 in 2OT. The line shifted to '+', cashing our Underdog POW on these pages as well as a 3★ LPS for us on Sat. TCU has held all 4 FBS foes to ssn lows in yards and KSt is #98 in the FBS on OFF averaging 39 ypg less than their foes allow. The 'Cats are 9-2 as a HD, while the Horned Frogs are 6-13 as an AF. Our line is based on QB Ertz being available.

MARSHALL by 24 over Old Dominion - The revenge tour for Marshall continues. The Herd is 2-1 SU/ATS in this series, but Old Dominion won last year. The Monarchs have dealt with a bunch of injuries, including their top RB and WR (both OFY). Marshall has won their L/3 by double-digits and outgained those foes by 110 ypg. The Monarchs have now lost 3 straight after falling to FAU. True Frosh QB Williams hit just 16-39-163-2-4 and now he faces our #41 ranked pass eff D. Marshall is +27 ypg while ODU is -145 ypg against similar schedule strength. Marshall is 15-8-1 as a HF while ODU is 1-7 as an AD.

Houston by 6 over TULSA - It's Homecoming weekend in Tulsa and this is their lone home game in a 4 week span. While Tulsa is on a 5-2 ATS series run, the visitor is 6-0 ATS. The Golden Hurricane should feel a bit of relief after having defended the option in B2B2B2B weeks, but they also allowed 280 (7.6) rush ypg vs 3 non-option foes and Houston, led by RB Catalan's 177 (8.1) ran for a season high 265 (6.6) last week! The Cougars were fortunate in their win over SMU last week as they were outgained 544-463 and capitalized on 2 int's inside their own 10 yard line. Tulsa's OFF will be on the field much more after being on the sideline much of the L/3 game vs option based teams and we feel will keep it closer than expected.

Middle Tenn by 6 over UAB - Last week UAB thrilled their homecoming fans with a win over CUSA contender Louisiana Tech. Middle Tenn enters off a home win over FIU despite QB Stockstill and WR James being out once again. QB Urzua had his best game as a starter. The Blue Raiders have outgained foes by 29 ypg but a closer look shows they are outgaining non-P5 foes by 128 ypg. UAB averages 203 (4.5) rush ypg, but Middle Tenn only allows 126 (3.1). MT is 10-5 as an AF and even if Stockstill doesn't return, QB Urzua is showing improvement. It will be tough for UAB to put that performance together 2 straight weeks so we'll lean with the favorite here.

ULM by 13 over Georgia St - ULM is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series. This is the lone HG in a 4 wk span for the Warhawks. GSt is on the 2nd of B2B AG's & their 4th consecutive road gm due to a scheduling change. QB Manning threw for a car high 422 yds w/a 3-0 ratio in LY's mtg. GSt has now won 2 straight after beating CC last week. WR Penny Hart had 132 yds and has 365 on the ssn. ULM has won 3 straight after smoking TXXSt w/a 20/3 yd edge. ULM has outgained foes by 17 ypg while GSt has been outgained by 17 ypg. ULM is 6-2-1 ATS overall and we'll lean with the Warhawks against a worn out Panthers team who hasn't played at home since week 1.

WKU by 7 over Charlotte - Oddly enough, this is the first ever meeting between these schools despite both being in the CUSA East the L3Y. WKU nearly hit rock bottom last week with the 'Toppers barely holding on to beat a lowly UTEP team that has an interim HC. Charlotte was outgained by 192 yards vs Marshall last week. HC Sanford seems to have sucked the life out of WKU's OFF, which is #125 in the FBS, averaging 119 ypg less than their foes allow (#10 LY). Charlotte isn't much better at #110, avg 98 ypg less than their foes allow and have been held to 7 points or less 4 times, but it's 2-0 ATS since changing OC's. Charlotte is 3-1 ATS in CUSA road games and pulled 2 outright upsets LY. We don't feel comfortable laying double digits with WKU so we'll side with Charlotte to keep it closer than expected.

UTAH ST by 7 over Wyoming - The Cowboys enter this matchup with some confidence after breaking a 4 gm series losing streak LY with a 52-28 (-4) home win. The Aggies are playing their 3rd consec HG in this one with mixed results thus far. After knocking off BYU by 16 a few wks back (Cougars 7 TO's), they were outgained by a 509-212 clip LW in the 13 pt loss to CSU. While the Cowboys are off a bye and own a 9-2 ATS run vs MW foes coming in, they do have a trip to Boise on deck. We'll go ahead and ride with the home squad in this one however as the Aggies have covered 4 of their past 5 as a HF and have enough capable talent to slow down WY QB Allen.

AIR FORCE by 7 over Unlv - While the visitor has covered the L/2 mtgs in this series, the home team clearly owned the matchup with an 8-0 ATS run prior. The Rebels head North following a 31 pt emotional home loss to SDSt (474-230 yd deficit). The Falcons meanwhile lost a last second battle vs rival Navy (GW TD /:15 left) but did help us cash our Top Weekly 4★ Totals Play (OVER 51.5) in easy fashion! Although this is AF's only home gm in a 5 wk span, we cannot lay more than a TD in this one as they are just 2-12 ATS following a matchup against a military rival (UNLV 18-7 ATS as an AD).

COLORADO ST by 26 over Nevada - First regular ssn matchup between these conf foes in 3 ssn's with the last meeting actually coming in the Arizona Bowl to close out the '15 ssn (NV won 28-23 as a 3 pt dog). The Rams delivered an impressive road win LW in Logan behind a 293 yd, 2 TD performance from QB Stevens. The Wolf Pack meanwhile earned their 1st win of '17 at home against Hawaii by putting up 566 yds of offense (+234 yds over ssn avg). While NV has covered 4 of their past 6 as a MW AD, the home tm is 5-1 SU/ATS in this series with NV losing their past 7 visits to Fort Collins by 23 ppg!

Appalachian St by 14 over IDAHO - App St has won all 3 mtgs SU incl their lone trip to the Kibbie Dome 47-20 (-20) in '15 when RB Moore set a schl frosh rec w/244 rush yds. ID enters off their HC & has a trip to SEC Mizzou on deck. The Mountaineers are just 5-10 ATS vs SBC foes, but are 8-2 as an AF, while the Vandals are 8-17 as a conf HD, but are on an 10-3 overall ATS run. However all 3 of those losses were in their 3 HG's TY. LW they were 7 pt HF vs Louisiana but lost outright 21-16. LW App st was outgained 532-425 & out FD'd 28-17 and trailed NMTst 31-24 mid 4Q as a 13.5 HF but thanks to 6 int's by the Aggies and a 56 yd td run with 2:12 left as they were trying to run out the clock App St won 45-31. App St has all the edges (#74-#121 Off, #63-#97 Def) and with the Vandals struggles in the Kibbie Dome TY, look for them to Pull away here.

USC by 7 over Utah - The Utes and bkp QB Williams suffered their 1st loss of the '17 campaign LW at home to Stanford despite a substantial 25-14 FD edge (-2 TO's). They now head West to take on a Trojans team seeking revenge after blowing a 4Q DD lean LY in SLC (Utah 31-27 win). A banged up Trojans squad got a bit of a schedule reprieve LW at home against OSU but did fail to cover the lofty 33 pt spread. While the Utes are on an 8-2 ATS run as an AD, the Trojans have covered all 3 meetings at home as P12 rivals. USC has failed to live up to their lofty hype and Utah is not getting enough respect here. We'll gladly take double-digits in this one.

Colorado by 17 over OREGON ST - It's HC wknd in Corvallis and the Beavers could use something to celebrate after losing their 4th game by 28+ pts to FBS competition. While Colorado comes in with a 10-1 ATS run away from home, they did suffer a surprising home loss to the Wildcats LW thanks to 12 penalties and being unable to stop AZ QB Tate (327 rush yds). While OSU does have their bye week on the horizon, we'll still go ahead and side with an angry Buffs

Navy is 2-0 SU/ATS all-time in this series, winning by an average of 19.5 ppg and covering by 24.5 ppg. This is the lone home game in a 4 week span for Memphis, while Navy enters off their emotional win over rival Air Force. We easily cashed OVER plays with both, using Navy/AF as our 4★ top total LPS on Sat and Memphis/UCConn as our Fri night Marquee. Tiger QB Ferguson had his third 6 td game and second 400 yd game last week and Navy has our #120 pass eff D. Navy QB Abey is a punishing runner as the Middies are averaging 400+ rush ypg and the Memphis D is short-handed due to injuries and allowed 350 (7.1) rush yards 2 weeks ago at UCF. The Tigers are 4-12 ATS in AAC home games and on a 5-9 overall ATS run, while the Middies are 7-2 ATS in AAC road games and on a 21-12 overall run. We'll gladly take the points and may not even need them.

Ucla by 6 over ARIZONA - The Wildcats are off a huge performance LW in Boulder where bkp signal-caller Tate set an FBS QB record with 327 rush yds in the 3 pt win. The Bruins meanwhile return from a bye following their own victory against the Buffs (4 pt home win as 7 pt chalk). We were surprised to see Arizona open as the favorite as the Bruins have quite the talent at QB in Rosen who is projected as a potential 1st Rnd DC in '18. With UCLA delivering 5 consec in this series SU & ATS (24 pt avg win), we'll call for them to get one here as they begin their stretch of 3 AG's in a 4-wk span.

Vanderbilt by 3 over MISSISSIPPI - Ole Miss is in revenge mode after losing last year on the road. The visitor is 6-3 SU/7-2 ATS and there have been 6 upsets in the L11Y. Ole Miss was getting absolutely crushed 35-3 and outgained 406-219 at halftime vs Auburn last week. The Rebels got a td with 2:57 left, getting a backdoor cover in the process. Vandy will be thrilled to play the Rebels, who can't run the ball (76 rush ypg, 2.9) after getting gashed in their L4 to the tune of 335 (6.5) rush ypg. QB Shurmur has a 12-1 ratio and he'll have all day to throw against a Rebels D that has just 4 sacks (Vandy has allowed just 3). The 'Dores are 15-10 as an AD and has a bye on deck. Ole Miss is on a 2-10 ATS run.

Oklahoma by 10 over Texas - The last three Red River Rivalry's have been decided by 7 points or less and Texas is on a 4-0 ATS series run. We hope many of you took advantage of the shift in line to -6', which cashed not only our Underdog POW against the 'Horns last week, but also a 3★ LPS selection. OU had their FBS leading 14 game win streak snapped as they suffered a monumental outright upset at home vs an ISU squad that was without their starting QB! The Sooners OFF, led by QB Mayfield, is #1 in the FBS averaging 223 ypg more than their foes allow. Texas is allowing just 66 (2.3) rush ypg and 53% completions with a 6-7 ratio their L4 games. It will be interesting to see how the Sooners respond to their huge upset loss under a first time HC.

Ohio St by 24 over NEBRASKA - Ohio St is 3-0 ATS in this series as B10 rivals, covering by an average of 22 ppg. Both have byes on deck, but Nebraska enters off a physical home loss to Wisconsin, while the Bucks are off an easy home win over Maryland, using their backups nearly the entire 2H. Since their loss to Oklahoma, Ohio St has looked every bit of the playoff contender they were picked to be in the pre-season. They're #2 in the FBS on OFF, averaging 219 ypg more than their foes allow and #8 on D, holding foes to 149 ypg less than their average. The Blackshirts D appeared to have taken a step forward under new DC Diaco, but were worn down by Wisconsin's rush attack and won't get any breaks in that department this week.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 28 over BYU - Last year was the first meeting s/'01 and BYU pulled out a win in 2OT. Miss St is off a much needed bye after getting crushed in B2B weeks at UGA and Aub. BYU enters off a Fri night home loss to Boise St. The Cougars have lost 5 straight by 20 ppg and have been outgained by 166 ypg vs P5 foes. Both tms ply'd LSU earlier with Miss St winning by 30 pts w/a +195 yd edge while BYU lost by 27 pts w/a -382 yd deficit. The Cougars are 0-6 ATS this year, while Miss St is 22-14 as a HF. The Bulldogs have huge edges on OFF, D and ST's and are looking to build their confidence back up so we'll lean with the chalk here.

ALABAMA by 28 over Arkansas - While Bama has won 10 straight in this series on the score-board, Arkansas is 6-4 ATS. HC Bielema is feeling some serious heat after last weeks loss at South Carolina. The final score was a bit misleading as Arkansas gave up 3 defensive td's. QB Wilson was injured and backup QB Kelley did lead 2 td drives in garbage time. Bama went 5 games without a TO until last week and QB Hurts has yet to throw an int. The Tide have held 5 of their 6 foes to season lows in yards and they're #5 in the FBS, holding opponents to 110 ypg below their average. Bama is 12-4 ATS vs SEC foes and on an 18-9-1 ATS run. Arkansas is on the second of B2B road gms, but are 14-7 as a dog.

OKLAHOMA ST by 28 over Baylor - It's homecoming in Stillwater. Both enter fresh off byes and Oklahoma St is 8-3 ATS in the series. This is the Pokes lone home game in a five week span. QB Rudolph is hitting 68% with a 16-4 ratio, while RB Hill has 516 (5.6) rush yds. Baylor has our #103 ranked pass eff D and is allowing 234 (5.3) rush ypg! Baylor has made progress while stepping up in class in their last two games, while OSU followed up their home loss to TCU with a more dominant than the final score indicated win at an improved Tx Tech. OKSt is 30-17 as a HF, while Baylor is 2-6 ATS in true road games.

GEORGIA by 28 over Missouri - The visitor is 4-1 ATS in this series as SEC rivals. Mizou enters off their fourth straight loss. They outgained KY by 82 yards but couldn't overcome 2 costly fumbles (both resulted in td's) and 2 missed fg's. QB Lock had his best game of the season with 355 yards (3-0 ratio), but now faces UGA's #15 pass eff D. The Dawgs D is #2 in the FBS, holding foes to 175 ypg below their average, while Mizou is just #116, allowing 79 ypg more than their foes average. UGA is 5-0 ATS vs FBS foes and has outscored their L3 SEC foes 134-17. Mizou is on a 1-7 ATS run in road games, but is plenty capable of pulling a backdoor cover.

New Mexico ST by 12 at GEORGIA SOUTHERN - It's Homecoming weekend in Statesboro. NMST is travelling for the 3rd str wk but has a bye on deck and is 3-0 ATS in this series. This will be their 3rd gm defending the option incl LW. The Eagles are 1-5 as a HF. The Aggies self destructed vs App St blowing a 31-24 Q4, thanks in part to 6 int's. They did have travel problems LW and arrived just hours before the game. GS has struggled TY as their option offense is avg just 220 ypg (4.0 ypc). NMST held New Mexico's Option to just 176 (4.8) rush in an upset in wk2. The Aggies have the OFF edge (#51-#115) and after facing the #38 & #29 pass eff D's now face the #52. We don't expect the Aggies to self-destruct for a 2nd straight week.

SOUTHERN MISS by 17 over UTEP - The visitor is this series is 5-2 SU/ATS. The Golden Eagles enter off an outright upset over UTSA as a DD dog. QB Keon Howard had the best game of his career, hitting 15-20-212-3-0 and RB Ito Smith added 178 (10.5) rush including an 89 yd td.

UTEP named former HC Mike Price as Interim HC last week and showed a better effort in their 1 point home loss vs WKU. The Miners put up a season high 287 yards and allowed a season low 282 yards. Southern Miss is the far better team, but are 0-5 as a HF vs FBS foes and we expect UTEP to play better under new leadership.

ARKANSAS ST by 20 over Coastal Carolina - This is the first ever meeting between these schools and it's homecoming weekend in Jonesboro. Ark St is fresh after having played just once in the last 21 days, while CC is travelling for the third time in 5 weeks. Red Wolves QB Hansen is hitting 65% w/a 14-6 ratio and CC has our #125 ranked pass eff D. The Red Wolves are 12-4 ATS vs SBC foes & 22-12 as a HF.

Utah by 3 over NORTH TEXAS - UTSA is 3-1 SU/ATS in the series. North Texas is a surprise contender in CUSA. The Mean Green come in having won 2 straight and fresh off a bye. Interesting enough, both teams most recent game came against Southern Miss with North Texas winning on the road (125 yd & +6 FD edges) while UTSA lost at home. UTSA has our #5 pass eff D and goes up against a North Texas OFF that averages 295 pass ypg behind QB Mason Fine (63%, 11-4). UTSA holds the edge on D, while North Tx has the edge on OFF & ST's. The Roadrunners are 4-0 ATS on the road. North Tx is 16-10 ATS at home.

FLORIDA by 7 over Texas A&M - The last meeting was A&M's first ever SEC game with Florida winning by a fg. The Gators look to a revenge minded LSU squad last week when it appeared they had the game tied but missed the PAT (bad snap). A&M trailed by 3 td's 3Q before rallying to lose by only 8 vs Bama. HC McElwain is an amazing 17-5 SU in one possession ball games so assuming this is a tight game, he gets the edge. UF is 14-7-1 ATS vs SEC foes. A&M is 3-11 ATS on the SEC road and HC Sumlin is just 3-11-1 ATS in the month of October.

TENNESSEE by 1 over South Carolina - HC Muschamp is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS vs the Vols with 3 outright upsets. SC is 6-2 ATS in the series and the L/5 meetings have been decided by a fg or less. Things are looking bleak in Knoxville with questions about whether Butch Jones has lost the team. The Vols are -48 ypg and have yet to cover the spread. Despite being 4-2, South Carolina is -55 ypg and benefitted from 3 def td's in their win last week. South Carolina has the edge on D, but Tenn has edges on OFF and ST's. Jones has done well off a bye (7-2 ATS) so we look for the Vols to circle the wagons and pull out a tight win, but that's not enough to cover the line.

STANFORD by 16 over Oregon - It's homecoming wknd on "The Farm" as the Ducks and their banged up offense (10 pts & 277 yds LW vs WSU w/o QB Herbert and WR's Nelson & Mitchell) head on the road inside of the P12 for the 2nd time TY (lost outright at ASU as 14' pt chalk). The Cardinal meanwhile where able to hand Utah their 1st loss of the ssn behind another big outing from Heisman contender Bryce Love (152 rush yds, 1240 on the ssn!). With the Cardinal having a bye week on deck along with being on a 3-gm roll following a pair of losses in Sept, we'll give them the 2 TD advantage here against a Ducks squad starting a stretch of 3 AG's in a 4-wk span.

Washington by 14 over ARIZONA ST - The Huskies head to the desert off a convincing home win against Cal where their defense held the Bears to just 93 td yds in the 31 pt victory. The Sun Devils meanwhile come in rested following a bye week and boasting some pretty good recent series history with 11 consec covers and SU wins of 10 straight prior to UW's 44-18 win (-27) LY. While Huskies HC Petersen is on a 29-13 ATS run as an AF, it's hard not to take the points with the home dog (8-3 ATS run) that has covered their previous 2 matchups in P12 play TY (won outright vs Oregon as 14' pt dog) and seeking revenge from their 1st outright series loss in more than a decade.

New Mexico by 6 over FRESNO ST - Fresno St is 4-0 SU/ATS in recent mtgs with an avg MOV of 19.3 ppg. The Bulldogs have rattled off B2B victories against some of the MW's lighter squads outscoring Nevada & SJSt by a 68-31 margin. The Lobos are well rested off a bye and on a 2-gm win streak of their own (11-5 ATS in conf AG's). While FSU DC Steinauer has done a solid job handling the defense in his 1st year away from Canada (career CFL coach, Bulldogs holding foes to 43 ypg under their ssn avg), it will be interesting to see how his schemes fare against their 1st option attack (NM #12 in FBS at 267 rush ypg).

HAWAII by 18 over San Jose St - Hawaii had their fair share of struggles LW at Nevada (14 pt loss) as 3 pt chalk while the Spartans lost their 6th straight versus FBS competition (47-12 avg defeat) LW at home against Fresno St (outgained 348-205). While the visitor is 4-1 SU/ATS in the series (3 upsets in the L/4 mtgs) and Hawaii is just 4-17 ATS in MW home games, we find it difficult to trust a 1st year HC traveling to the islands in this one (SJSt 3-15 ATS as an AD).

USF by 22 over Cincinnati - These schools have played every year s/'03 as conference rivals in CUSA, the Big East, and now the AAC. USF is on a 3-1 ATS series run. The Bulls enter fresh off a bye and have hit their stride in the L/3 games under new HC Strong. Cincy had their home game vs UCF called just before the start of the 4Q last week, but still allowed 515 yards as their transition to a new coach isn't going as well. They've played much better on the road, covering all 3 of their games this year and are 7-3 as an AD. The Bulls however, are 10-1-1 as a HF.

MIAMI, FL by 10 over Georgia Tech - This is the Jackets first true road game. Miami is on a 7-1 SU/ATS run in this series. HC Richt is plenty familiar with GT from his UGA days and is 14-2 SU/11-4-1 ATS vs the Jackets. Miami enters off their emotional win over FSU cashing our 3★ on these pages, but lost RB Walton (OFY). QB Rosier had his first real test and while he threw for 254 yards and 3 td's, he hit just 43%. GT has outgained foes by 219 ypg. The Canes are #56 on D, holding foes to 21 ypg below their season average while the Jackets' D is #19, holding foes to 85 ypg below their average and they've held their L/2 opponents to season lows in yards.

The Jags meanwhile beat PIT for the 1st time in a decade behind rookie RB Fournette (181 rush yds, 2 TD's) & 5 int's of Big Ben (2 ret'd for TD's). While the Rams are on just a 3-12-2 ATS run overall following the defeat to SEA, there's value for them here as JAX has posted just a 5-23 ATS mark against NFC foes and don't get the advantage of playing against a West Coast tm early in the day w/a 4pm Kickoff.

Big game for CAR as far as the sked is concerned as this home matchup against PHI is their only game in Charlotte over a 5 wk span (CAR 13-6 ATS as a NDIV HF). This is however the Eagles' only road matchup in a 6 wk span as they have 3 HG's followed by a bye week on the horizon. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

HOUSTON by 14 over Cleveland - The seat is clearly getting hotter for Browns HC Jackson as his squad has now dropped 20 of 21 during his tenure following a home defeat to the Jets (CLE 21-14 FD & 419-212 yd edges but 3-1 TO deficit). The Texans meanwhile found themselves in an early hole LW at home vs KC (trailed 23-7 at HT) while also losing DL Watt and LB Mercilus w/injuries. With HOU an impressive 8-1 ATS as a NDIV HF and the Browns on just a 3-12 overall ATS run and questions on who will be under center following the benching of rookie Kizer (Kevin Hogan 194 pass yds, 2-1 ratio In 2H), the smart money is clearly on the Texans in this one.

New England by 7 over NY JETS - Somebody should have told the Jets' coaches and players that they were supposed to be tanking this ssn! All they've done since their 0-2 start is rattle off 3 consec victories including a road win LW in CLE (Browns 419-212 yd edge). They now take on a Patriots squad that they've surprisingly had solid home success against with 4 consec covers that includes 2 outright upset wins. While the FD's & yards were on the board for another shootout against the Bucs (49 & 811 respectively), the results didn't match in the final score with NE escaping Tampa with a 19-14 win (TB missed 3 FG's, incompleton in EZ on final play). Although they do have extra rest after playing last Thur, they are on just a 2-7 ATS run as a DIV AF. With the Jets posting a 9-2 ATS mark as a DIV HD, we find it hard to lean with the Patriots by more than a TD this week.

ATLANTA by 14 over Miami - The bye week couldn't have come at a better time for the Falcons as they lost a handful of offensive weapons in their upset loss to BUF a few wks back in ATL. The Dolphins meanwhile are playing their 4th AG in a 5 wk span after they were forced into a Wk 1 bye due to Irma (scheduled HG vs TB). They head North following a 6 pt win against a banged-up Titans squad (no Mariota) having recorded just 18 combined offensive pts over the L/3 wks (just 178 yds vs TEN). While the Falcons are just 5-12 ATS vs AFC foes, we'll gladly lay the points as some of those injured players are expected to return (incl Julio Jones) in this one.

NEW ORLEANS by 7 over Detroit - After sporting one of the league's worst defenses in each of the previous 3 yrs, the Saints have shown vast improvement so far in '17 by trimming their ppg down to 19.5 thus far including a shutout of MIA 2 wks ago in London. They now return from their week off (6-1-1 ATS off a bye) to take on the Cardiac Cats who nearly delivered yet another comeback LW vs the Panthers w/a pair of TD's in the final 6 min (3 pt loss). In their Superdome meeting a ssn ago DET came in as a 6' pt dog and left with the 28-13 outright upset (QB Stafford 341 pass yds & 2 TD). With the Saints seeking revenge and now having a consistent defense to match an already dangerous offense, we'll go ahead and give them the edge in this one.

Green Bay by 3 over MINNESOTA - The Packers have had some success in their recent trips to MIN with wins in 3 of their past 4. They earned another comeback victory on the shoulder (and legs) of QB Rodgers LW (11 yd GW TD pass w/11 left) vs DAL. The Vikings have been decimated on the offensive side of the ball over the past few weeks with QB Bradford missing all but the opener and rookie standout RB Cook now being lost to an ACL. While MIN is a solid 14-5 ATS in their recent home matchups, we'll give the FG lean with the Packers here as they're on an 8-3 ATS run overall and get an extra day of rest with MIN visiting the Bears on MNF.

BALTIMORE by 7 over Chicago - The Ravens used a strong 1Q performance against the Raiders (incl Def FR TD) in their 30-17 win to move their NDIV record to a still dismal 3-11 ATS. CHI meanwhile made the switch at QB entering MNF vs MIN with rookie Trubisky taking over for the ineffective Glennon. While the Bears are 2-0 ATS as of presstime at home, the Bucs and Packers have outscored them by a 64-21 margin on the road (only all'g 286 ypg but -7 TO's). With Trubisky getting his 1st career start away from home and on short rest to boot, BAL gets the call to claim a 2nd consec victory in this one.

WASHINGTON by 14 over San Francisco - The 49ers are on the road for a 3rd consec week following B2B OT losses against ARZ and IND. The Redskins meanwhile come in well rested after a week off (2-7 ATS) and looking to get back on track after a MNF defeat in KC. While SF HC Shanahan would absolutely love to get the inaugural win of his career against the team

that fired both him and his father (OC & HC respectively at WAS from '10-'13), the 49ers are on just a 6-14 ATS run coming in. With the Redskins on a solid 16-7 ATS run themselves entering the meeting, we'll go ahead and give them the 2-TD edge here.

Tampa Bay by 4 over ARIZONA - The Cardinals could easily be sitting at 0-5 heading into Wk 6 as their lone victories have come in OT against the Colts & 49ers. In their loss LW in PHI that saw us claim a 3★ Newsletter Winner, the Eagles jumped out to a 21-0 1Q lead and never looked back (27 pt victory). The Bucs have extended rest heading to the desert although it's worth mentioning that they could be carrying a 2-gm win streak if it wasn't for a trio of missed FG's (lost by 5). With ARZ now on a 3-13 ATS run overall and TB claiming ATS victories in 6 of their past 9 road games overall, we'll give the Bucs the 4 pt victory here.

OAKLAND by 1 over LA Chargers - It's panic time for the Silver & Black following a 3rd consec defeat LW against the Ravens as BAL finished w/a 365-245 yd edge. They now welcome a Chargers squad who ended their 9 gm losing streak LW against the winless Giants (10 pts in last 4:50). While the Chargers still come in on a dismal overall spread slide (1-8-1 ATS) and the Raiders have swept the series in each of the L2Y, the MOV in those matchups have been by 3, 3, 3 & 8. With OAK just 3-10 ATS as a DIV HF and the Chargers losing by less than a score on 6 occasions during that previously mentioned losing skid, a narrow lean is all that we can give the Raiders with Derek Carr still expected to be on the shelf.

Indianapolis at TENNESSEE - MNF - After an impressive 31-10-1 ATS mark inside the AFC South from '07-'14, the Colts have come back to reality the past 2 yrs with a 4-7-1 ATS DIV mark. They do head to Nashville off an OT victory over the 49ers however (447-402 yd edge). Following a dismal outing in HOU where they were gashed for 57 pts (now 8-27 ATS vs DIV foes), the Titans were unable to get anything going on the offensive end without Mariota (still had a 188-178 yd edge vs MIA). There's plenty of questions entering this MNF matchup as it remains unclear whether Mariota (hammy) and Andrew Luck (missed F/5 gms w/shldr) will be under center.
