These two last met back in 1964 and 1966 when they split two meetings. Indiana is playing for their first CFB National Title. Curt Cignetti coached in the FCS National Title game in 2019 at James Madison but lost to North Dakota St. Miami has won 5 National Titles but the last was back in '01 when they crushed Nebraska.

We've heard that the "U" is back numerous times over the last 20 years, only for Miami to fall short each time. This year appeared to be more of the same. They beat Notre Dame in the opener but losses to Louisville and SMU kept them from the ACC Title game. The win over ND was enough for an at-large bid. Miami's D held Texas A&M to 3 points and Ohio St to 10 points in their first 2 playoff games. Carson Beck looked like the projected #1 draft pick vs Ole Miss in the Semifinals, throwing for 268 and 2 td's in a 31-27 win. The 'Canes D is allowing just 293 ypg and they have 47 sacks led by DE's Bain and Mesidor. The D holds foes 117 ypg below their avg.

Indiana has passed all tests heading into this game. They went 12-0 in the regular season with only 3 close wins. The Hoosiers knocked off Ohio St for their first Big 10 Title then crushed Alabama 38-3 in the quarterfinals. Last week's rematch with Oregon was a 56-22 route thanks to +3 TO's. We give Indiana a big edge on offense. QB Mendoza has more td passes (8) than incompletions (5) in their 2 playoff games and they have two of the best WR's in CFB in Cooper and Sarraat. Their D allows just 11 ppg/261 ypg and holds foes 107 ypg below their avg (#7 in FBS).

Miami has a rare home field edge playing this game at Hard Rock Stadium in Miami. Don't be shocked if Indiana has just as many fans though as Indiana has the largest living alumni base in the country and they packed Mercedes Benz Stadium last week! PP calls for Indiana to win a low scoring 24-14 game. We think this will be a hard-hitting game and expect the defenses to shine.

FORECAST: UNDER 47.5 RATING: 3★

BUF comes in off a 27-24 Wild Card win at JAX where Allen threw for 273 yds and BUF had to grind it out late. Now they head to Denver on a 2nd straight road game, and that travel spot has been brutal historically (32-64 SU over the last 20 years). BUF is also on short rest, and the Divisional Round trend is ugly for this profile too: teams that won as underdogs in the Wild Card round are just 8-30 SU since 2003. DEN is off the bye at 14-3 SU after winning the AFC West, and Payton has been strong on extended prep in the postseason (4-0 SU).

BUF's offense can obviously travel with Allen (3,668 pass yds, 25-10) plus the run game (2,714 rush yds at 5.0) led by Cook (1,621 at 5.2) and Allen's 14 rush TD's. The issue is what they're missing now: WR Gabe Davis is out for the playoffs (ACL), TE Kincaid is questionable (lower leg/knee, boot precaution), and S Poyer is out (hamstring). That's a lot in a playoff road spot where you need both pass-game depth and back-end stability, especially against a DEN defense that can make you earn everything at altitude.

DEN's offense is balanced and efficient with QB Nix at 3,931 pass yds (25-11) and a run game that can keep them on schedule (2,018 rush yds at 4.4). Sutton is the #1 (1,017) with Franklin as a steady #2 (709), and the run game has multiple looks with Dobbins (772 at 5.0) plus Nix's legs (356, 5 TD). DEN's defense has real production on paper with Cooper (8 sks), Strnad (4.5), and an active coverage group led by Riley Moss (19 PD) and Surtain (12 PD). Injury-wise, LB Dre Greenlaw is questionable/limited (hamstring), but the overall setup still leans DEN at home.

PP calls for DEN, with the computer projecting a 24-20 Broncos win (4-point edge). The run game is basically even (DEN 136 rush yds / BUF 132), and the pass projections point to a controlled pace (BUF 190 pass yds / DEN 176), so this comes down to who wins the small edges and finishes drives. DEN has the ST advantage (#21 vs #27), which matters in a tight game where field position swings decide quarters, and even though BUF gets a projected TO edge (+2 vs -3) the projection still favors DEN to manage the game better at home and separate late.
