

1st mtg & 1st time in this bowl for both. CM is in a bowl for the 6th time this decade, but are 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS in their L/4 bowls. First yr CM HC McElwain is 2-1 SU all-time in bowls. SDSt is in a bowl for the 10th str yr (4-5 ATS) but haven't won SU/ATS s/16.

CM was 1-11 LY & with 11 ret starters, were picked last in the MAC West. They opened an expected 2-2 but that incl a 5 pt loss at UM as a 30 pt AD. After a loss to rival WM, they won 6 of their final 7 reg ssn MAC gms (only loss at UB, -4 TO) to win the division. They were a 6 pt fav in the MAC Chmp gm. They allowed a MU to be the CMC & dearing hold ML for a full to 5 or do in 11. ret the opening KO to the CM2 & despite hold MU to 56 yds in 1H only led 14-10 & lost 26-21. The offense avg 445 ypg, which was 46 yds over their FBS opp avg allowed (#39). The offense was led by Tenn transfer QB Dormady (2148, 67%, 14-6), VT transfer WR Pimpleton (823, 10.4, 6 td) & two RB's with 975+ yds. HC Long led SDSt to a bowl gm every ssn here (3-5 SU/ATS). SDSt barely got by Weber St in the opener (6-0) but won 23-14 at UCLA. After losing to UTSt in their MW opener, SDSt won 4 str before losing at home to Nev 17-13. SDSt then lost at UH which cost them a spot in the MW Title gm. SDSt was led by their stout DEF which held tims to 289 ypg (#5 FBS), 111 ypg under their ssn avg (#6 FBS) and gave up 72 rush ypg (#2 FBS) & 12.8 ppg (#4 FBS). SDSt's rush attack dipped TY (135 ypg, 3.3 ypc) but QB Agnew was the first QB here s/ 14 to top 2,000 yds passing in a ssn. The OFF avg'd only 329 yds & 19 pts and all but 2 of SDSt's gms TY were decided by 10 pts or less.

SDSt has a huge edge on DEF & ST's. CM has been held to pts or less 5 times this ssn, including their last gm. Aztec gms have gone under the total 6 str & went over just once all ssn.

The Flames made their 1st bowl in their 1st ssn of eligibility. It's their 1st post-ssn appearance since making the FCS playoffs in '14. The Eagles have won all 3 prior mtgs but the last was in '96 (FCS). GS is 2-0 SU in bowls & won the Camellia Bowl LY on a GW FG as time exp'd.

Under 1st yr HC Freeze, Liberty ret'd 15 str's but opened 0-2 losing to 'Cuse 24-0 (+19) & ULL 35-14 (+14), who GS lost to 37-24 (+3). While LU won the next 5, only 1 was over a FBS bowl tm (UB 35-17 +4) & 2 were vs FCS foes. LU was 7' pt chalk vs Rutgers but lost by 10. After destroying UMass, LU lost to BYU & UVA but needing to win 7 (only count 1 win over FCS) beat NMSt for a 2nd time. LU's OFF avg 443 ypg but some of that was due to facing poor DEF's as they avg -7 ypg (#81) under what their FBS foes all'd. The OFF is led by QB Calvert (3393, 59%, 26-5) & WR Gandy-Golden, who's 1,333 vds (18.0, 9 td) is almost 1,000 more than the #2. The OL has paved the way for 4.6 ypc. While they all'd 27 sks, 15 were in the F/4 gms. While the DEF has 32 sks, they've all'd 423 ypg (31 over FBS foes avg, #93) despite several gms where they slowed down their OFF to help the DEF.

HC Lunsford has turned GS around & ret'd 14 st'rs from their 10-3 squad LY. GS began 1-3 & were w/o QB Werts for most of their F/3 gms. GS turned it around, winning their next 4, incl a 24-21 upset at #20 App St. GS split their L/4 to finish 7-5. GS's OFF was once again led by a strong rush attack (261, 5.0) led by RB's King (776, 4.4) & Kennedy (760, 6.9, susp F/4 gms) & QB Werts (676, 4.5) GS's pass eff D ranks #93, but their run DEF was solid, all'g 137 ypg (3.8) & they recorded 11 sks the L/3 wks after just 13 the F/9

Liberty does have the advantage of several wks to prepare for the option and did see it earlier this ssn vs NM.

FORECAST: LIBERTY (+) **BATING: 1** 1st mtg. SMU is bowling for just the 2nd time the L6Y. HC Dykes is 2-0 SU/ATS in bowls, winning while at LT & Cal. FAU is 3-0 SU/ ATS in bowls incl here in '17, 50-3 (-22') vs Akron. HC Kiffin has moved on to Ole Miss (DC Spencer is interim). Spencer has previ-

ously been DC at OKSt & Charlotte. SMU fell 1 gm shy of being bowl elig in '18, but ret'd 16 str's TY & added TX grad trans QB Buechele. The Ponies reeled off 8 str wins to begin the ssn & were ranked as high as #15! They suffered their 1st loss at eventual AAC Champ Memphis (+39 yds) & alternated wins & losses their L/4. Both losses were on the road with each being 1 poss gms. Buechele had a sensational ssn, compl 63% w/a 33-9 ratio as SMU finished the reg ssn #9 FBS on OFF, avg 102 ypg more than their foes allow. RB Jones had his 2nd 1,000 yd ssn of his car, rushing for a car high 1,249 (5.4) w/21 td's! The Ponies do struggle on DEF however, as they enter #91 FBS all'g 28 ypg more than their foes avg, but did finish with 50 sks!

FAU ret'd 13 str's (#67 most exp'd) from a disappointing 5-7 ssn in '18. The Owls started 0-2, but their losses were to UCF & at OSU. FAU won 4 str then lost to Marshall when they all'd the GW td w/:36 left. The Owls rebounded to win their next 6. incl the CUSA Title am 49-6 (-8) over UAB. Just like '17, the Owls are 10-3 & ply'g at home, but must do so w/o HC Kiffin. All 10 of FAU's wins have come by DD's & they own 5 wins over bowl foes. FAU avg 450 ypg & is +77 ypg at home & +201 ypg their L/4. The Owls avg 72 ypg more than their foes allow (#15 FBS). QB Robison is hitting 61% w/a 26-6 ratio & TE Bryant is a Mackey Finalist (1004, 15.4).

Interesting to note that the st'g QB's transferred from TX & OU so this is a mini "RRR." FAU sold out their bowl the last time they hosted and figure to do so again this year, despite the loss of their HC. The Checklist favors FAU & they are getting points. FORECAST: FAU (+)

4★ Dallas over PHILADELPHIA - After narrow DIV victories against the Giants (trailed 17-3 at HT, won in OT) and the Redskins (GW TD pass w/:26 left) to put themselves in prime position to capture the NFC East Title, the final step for the Eagles comes this weekend at home against a DAL squad who also moved back to .500 on the year following a 23 pt home win over the Rams (RB Elliott 117 rush yds & 2 TD's). In their earlier meeting back in Wk 7 on SNF, DAL captured their 3rd consec vic-tory in the series by jumping out to a 27-7 lead in the eventual 27 pt victory (402-283 yd edge). With DAL now outgaining the Eagles by a 978-539 clip over their past 2 contests and going an amazing 14-2 ATS in recent matchups against their DIV foes, we have no issue giving them a TD edge here as PHI has also failed to cover 6 of their past 8 NFC East home games. FORECAST: Dallas by 10 3+ Baltimore over CLEVELAND - Following a 14 pt loss in the desert against the Cardinals to end their playoff aspirations, the Browns return home looking for their 1st season sweep of the Ravens in 12 yrs. Since CLE's surprising 40-25 (+7) victory in BAL way back in Wk 4 where they finished with a 530-395 yd edge, the Ravens have been virtually unstoppable with 10 consecutive victories (18 pt avg MOV) including an easy 21 point Thur night win over the Jets that saw QB Jackson throw for another 5 TD's. With the Ravens clinging onto the #1 spot in the AFC and covering 7 of their L/8 coming in, we expect them to earn some revenge in the final game played in front of the "Dawg FORECAST: Baltimore by 17 Pound" this season.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2* TENNESSEE over New Orleans - Following just their 2nd defeat in the L/8 tries LW at home against the Texans, the Titans take on a Saints squad who heads to Nashville on short rest after hosting the Colts on MNF. In their most recent meeting back in '15, the Titans won for a 5th time in 6 matchups with a 34-28 OT victory (483-416 yd edge). While the Saints have covered 7 of their L/9 NDIV AG's, we're leaning with the Titans here as they've gone 12-6-1 ATS against recent NFC foes and need a win here to keep their AFC playoff hopes alive. FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 4 and need a win here to keep their AFC playoff hopes alive. OTHER PLAYS

SAN FRANCISCO by 3 over LA Rams - Saturday - Following a surprising 23 pt loss a week ago on the road against the Cowboys, the Rams head North to take on a 49ers squad that picked up a relatively easy victory earlier TY behind a suffocating defense that held the Rams offense to just 7 pts, 10 FD's & 157 yds. The 49ers also come into action after a defeat however as ATL (+11) got a GW TD w/:02 left. While we expect the Rams to give their best shot in this one with a 9-4-1 ATS mark against DIV foes, the 49ers get the FG lean as they look to get back on track prior to their crucial Wk 17 matchups against the Seahawks.

NEW ENGLAND by 3 over Buffalo - Saturday - The Patriots return to Foxboro after ending their 2-game losing skid a week ago in CIN (21 pt win, +5 TO's). The Bills meanwhile remain a game back in the AFC East following an impressive SNF win in Heinz Field against the Steelers where their Def all'd just 10 pts, 15 FD's & 229 yds. In their earlier Wk 4 meeting in BUF, the Patriots used a blocked punt TD along with 4 BUF int's to come away with the 16-10 victory (BUF 23-11 FD & 375-224 yd edges). With the Bills on a 7-1-2 ATS run when listed as a DIV AD and the previously mentioned stat edges in the prior meeting, we find it difficult to give the Patriots more than a FG edge in this one. Houston by 1 over TAMPA BAY - Saturday - Following a successful trip to Nashville that saw them

get a stronger grip on the AFC South lead, the Texans are back on the road for the final time to take on a Bucs squad that extended their winning streak to 4 in a row LW in DET behind a 458 vd, 4 TD effort from QB Winston. In their most recent matchup in '15, the Texans claimed their 3rd consec DD victory over the Bucs with 30-14 FD & 413-318 yd edges. While we'll go ahead and call for that streak of DD victories to end this time around with HOU potentially looking ahead with canother key showdown against the Titans on deck, we still believe that they have enough talent to pick up a narrow win in this one

DENVER by 3 over Detroit - After a rough trip to snowy Arrowhead that saw them clinch a losing record for the 3rd consec year (KC 27-15 FD & 419-251 yd edges), the Broncos are back at home to take on a struggling Lions squad who dropped their 7th straight contest LW at home against the Bucs with their Def getting gashed for 38 pts, 23 FD's & 495 yds. In their trip to Ford Field back in '15, the Broncos picked up a 24-12 victory behind a solid 354-290 yd edge. While the Lions have failed to cover 9 in a row coming in and the Broncos are on a 7-3 ATS run, keep in mind that DEN has struggled in their role as a NDIV HF with just a 1-5-1 ATS mark.

LA CHARGERS by 10 over Oakland - Following an emotional final game inside of the "Black Hole" a week ago against the Jaguars where they blew a 16-3 HT lead, the Raiders head to LA to take on a Chargers squad seeking revenge from Wk 10 debacle in OAK that saw QB Rivers toss 3 int's in a 2 pt defeat (LAC had won the prior 4 SU & ATS with a 13 pt avg MOV). The Chargers momentum from their 45-10 win in JAX 2 weeks ago was short lived as MIN came into Carson a week ago and handed them a 29 pt defeat (LAC 7 TO's!!). Despite LW's performance and continued issues with the aging Rivers under center, we'll call for the Chargers to earn a comfortable win this time around as the Raiders have failed to cover 7 of their L/8 as a DIV AD.

ATLANTA by 10 over Jacksonville - If you're a fan of recent trends, this isn't the matchup for you as the Jaguars head to ATL on just a 4-24 ATS run against the NFC while the Falcons have now failed to cover 13 straight in their own non-conf battles. Both come into this meeting off of "Bay Area" upset victories as JAX overcame a 16-3 HT deficit in the final game played inside of the "Black Hole" (GW TD pass w/:31 left) while the Falcons got their own GW TD pass w/:02 left against the 49ers. In their most recent matchup back in '15, the Falcons (+3) claimed a 23-17 upset victory (3rd win in 4 tries). With the Jaguars dropping 5 of their L/6 (SU & ATS) coming in and ATL playing with much more confidence since their return from bye, we'll see no issue giving the home team a DD edge.

WASHINGTON by 4 over NY Giants - While it's been a rough season overall in the NFC East with no team posting a winning record heading into Wk 16, the Redskins and Giants have been the bottom feeders of the entire league with a combined 6-22 mark. The Redskins actually had a lead with less than :30 remaining LW at home against the Eagles before PHI got a pair of TD's to earn a 10 pt win (4 yd TD pass, 47 yd FR TD). The Giants meanwhile overcame a 10-7 HT deficit at home against the Dolphins in the eventual 16 pt victory (RB Barkley 143 ttl yds & 2 TD's). In their earlier matchup back in Wk 4 of the season, we used our **Sept Game of the Month** on the Giants (-3) who picked up the easy 24-3 victory with a dominant 389-176 yd edge. With WAS being the much more consistent team this time around, we'll go ahead and give a slight lean in their direction.

Pittsburgh by 1 over NY JETS - Following a 17-10 home defeat LW against the Bills where they had 5 TO's, the Steelers head East to take on a Jets squad that comes into this meeting with extra rest after a rough road trip to BAL that saw the Ravens finish with 23-13 FD & 430-310 yd edges. In their most recent matchup back in '16, the Steelers (-8') won 31-13 (433-316 yd edge) for their 3rd victory in 4 tries against the Jets. While PIT has covered 8 of their past 12 contests overall coming in, they have failed to cover 5 of their past 6 when listed as an AF. With the Jets going 10-5-2 ATS as a HD including a trio of outright upset wins already TY (DAL, NYG, OAK), we're giving the Steelers only the slightest of leans.

MIAMI by 1 over Cincinnati - At one point earlier in the season this appeared to be a battle for the #1 overall pick in the 2020 Draft. While CIN continues to hold up their end of the bargain following their 13th loss in 14 tries LW at home against the Patriots (5-0 TO deficit in 21 pt defeat), the Dolphins have gone 3-4 since their ugly 0-7 beginning. In their early season trip to CIN LY, the Bengals overcame a 14-0 HT deficit with 24 unanswered pts (2 def TD's) in the 4Q of the eventual 27-17 win. While MIA has covered 7 of their past 10 coming in, they have gone just 8-24 ATS overall when listed as a NDIV HF. With CIN covering 11 of their L/15 as an AD, we'll give them a legitimate chance to keep this one close. INDIANAPOLIS by 7 over Carolina - The Panthers head into IND having dropped 6 consec matchups (1-4-1 ATS) following a 6 pt home defeat against the Seahawks that saw QB Allen throw 3 more int's. The Colts meanwhile return home on short rest after a MNF road trip to the Superdome. In their most recent meeting back in '15, the Panthers blew a 23-6 lead in the 4Q before eventually winning with a 52-yd FG in OT. With the Colts on a 12-5-1 ATS run against the NFC overall and playing much more consistently throughout the season, we'll go ahead and give them a TD edge in this one as it appears that many of the Panthers players have already packed it in for 2019.

SEATTLE by 7 over Arizona - Following their 7th road win in 8 tries LW in Charlotte against the Panthers where RB Carson rushed for 133 yds & 2 TD's, the Seahawks are back at home for the final 2 weeks of the season. The Cardinals meanwhile head to the Pacific NW after snapping a 6-gm losing skid LW at home against the Browns (RB Drake 137 rush yds & 4 TD's). In their earlier matchup back in Wk 4, the Seahawks (-5') jumped out to a 20-3 HT lead in the eventual 27-10 victory (SEA's 3rd consec win over ARZ). While the Cardinals (3-6-1 ATS run vs DIV foes) are simply just playing out the rest of their schedule with another Top 10 Draft pick likely in their future, we're cutting off our lean at a TD for SEA here as they've failed to cover 6 of the L/7 as a DIV HF and could be caught looking ahead to their pivotal home matchup against the NFC West-leading 49ers.

Kansas City at CHICAGO - SNF - After an 8 pt road defeat LW in Lambeau that knocked them out of playoff contention in the NFC (CHI 20-12 FD & 415-292 yd edges, -3 TO's), the Bears return home to take on a Chiefs squad that remains a game back of the Patriots for the #2 spot in the AFC following a 20 pt win at home against the Broncos inside of snowy Arrowhead (KC 27-15 FD & 419-251 yd edges). In their most recent meeting way back in '15, the Bears overcame a 17-3 HT deficit with 15 unanswered 2H pts in the 18-17 victory (7-yd GW TD pass w/:18 left). While HC Nagy would love to see his Bears knock off his old team again here (OC under HC Reid from '16-'17), the Chiefs are 6-1 SU (5-2 ATS) away from home this season. Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marguee Winner!

Green Bay at MINNESOTA - MNF - Following an 8 pt win LW in Lambeau over the Bears, the Packers head to MIN looking to clinch the NFC North against a Vikings squad who forced the Chargers into 7 TO's in their 39-10 victory. In their 1st meeting of the ssn back in Wk 2, the Packers (-2') jumped out to a 21-10 HT lead in the eventual 5 pt victory (MIN 421-335 yd edge, -2 TO's). While GB has now covered 3 consec games in this series overall and QB Cousins is 0-8 SU/ATS all-time on MNF, it's also worth mentioning that MIN is a completely different team inside of US Bank Stadium where they've covered 22 of the L/31 as a HF. HC Blake Anderson has led Ark St to 6 bowl gms in 6 ssn's, but is just 1-4 SU/ATS after a 16-13 loss to Nev in OT LY in the Arizona Bowl.

FIU was the #17 most experienced team entering '19 with 16 returning starters back incl QB Morgan. They got off to a rocky 1-3 start then won 3 straight before alternating losses with wins in their L/5. They got bowl eligible by pulling off the biggest upset in school history, beating HC Davis' former employer, Miami 30-24 (+20'). FIU avg 386 ypg but they've been held below that number in 6 straight (avg 328 L/6). The Panthers have only faced our #122 sked. QB Morgan is completing 58% but his to passes have been cut in half this year with just 13. FIU allows 206 (5.1) rush ypg. FIU is 2-5 SU/ ATS and -88 ypg vs Bowl foes and 0-5 SU/1-4 ATS outside of Miami

Ark St brought back 13 st'rs but lost the #2 all-time leading passer in school history. Ark St started the ssn 2-2, but lost QB Bonner for the ssn to an inj. Ark St lost 2 of their F/3 SBC gms & were 3-4 on the ssn. Despité the inj's mounting (14 st'rs missed at least 1 gm to inj), Ark St won 4 of their L/5 gms incl a win vs GSthrn. Bkp Hatcher filled in well (2561, 68%, 23-9) & WR Bayless (SBC POY) was #2 in the FBS w/ 1,481 yds & 16 td's. Ark St avg'd 306 pass yds (#14 FBS). Ark Sts DEF ranked #127, all'g 482 ypg & their foes to gain 66 ypg above their ssn avg (#114 FBS). The inj's on the DL (4 DT's OFY) led Ark St to giving up 224 rush ypg, while their pass D improved during the ssn, giving up 197 ypg the L/6 gms. Our checklist to the left leans with FIU & they are getting points.

Boise's DEF, led by MW DPOY DE Curtis Weaver (50 tkl, 13.5 sks), held teams to 67 ypg under their ssn avg & 112 rush ypg (3.5 ypc) & their pass eff D is #33. Boise's OFF avg'd 442 yds & 37 pts and was led by MW frosh of the year RB Holani (979, 5.4 ypc). Boise was 7-1 SU/5-3 ATS vs bowl tms. Interesting that this will be UW HC Petersen's last gm & it will be

against his former tm. We'll call for him to go out on top. FORECAST: WASHINGTON RATING: 4*





USC is making their 3rd trip (1-1 SU) here & HC Helton is back in a bowl after missing LY (2-2 in bowls here). This is Iowa's 4th Holiday Bowl but 1st s/'91. Iowa is bowling for the 7th str yr, but has won just 2 of their L/6 (3-3 ATS)

LY USC missed a bowl for the first time s/'11 and 11 st'rs but had to replace 5 of their top 8 tkl'rs. QB Daniels was inj'd & OFY in the opener, then bkp Slovis started the next 3 gms but was inj'd vs Utah (USC won 30-23), so Matt Fink started against Wash. Slovis came back vs ND, but USC would lose & drop to 3-3. Slovis started the rest of the ssn & USC went 5-1 to finish the year. Slovis hit 72% w/a 28-9 ratio & WR Pittman led a talented WR group w/ 1,222 yds (11 td), but a true #1 RB did not emerge. USC's OFF avg'd 83 ypg more than their foes typically all'd (#13 FCS). USC DEF gave up over 400 ypg (415 ypg) for the 1st time s/ 15, but the run DEF improved over the L/6 gms, giving up 136 ypg (197 ypg the F/6 gms) & the pass DEF ranks #66.

Iowa is always a threat in the B10 under HC Ferentz, regardless of how much exp is returning. The Hawkeyes only had 10 ret str's for 19, but opened the ssn 4-0. After B2B losses at UM & vs PSt, Iowa won 5 of their L/6, with the lone loss by just 2 at UW (-178 yds). The Hawkeyes won every gm SU as chalk, & lost all 3 SU as a dog. 3rd yr Sr st'r QB Stanley didn't progress as much as anticipated, throwing for 2,738 (59%, 14-7). Iowa cont's to be stellar on D, ranking #18 FBS holding opponents to 81 ypg less than their avg. A win here will give Iowa DD's victories in a ssn for just the 2nd

time this decade, while HC Helton is off the hot seat for the time being. QB Stanley didn't have the type of ssn he projected and will look to have his best outing of the season against an avg at best D. FORECAST: IOWA RATING: 3*



First mtg. This is the 2nd Cheez-It Bowl, but this bowl has been around for 30 years (formerly the Copper, BW3, Insight & Catcus Bowl). This is the 2nd trip here for both tms (AF lost in '95 & WSU won in '92). This is AF's 10th bowl gm under HC Calhoun (4-5 SU/5-4 ATS) while WSU is in their 6th bowl under HC Leach (2-3 SU/1-4 ATS).

After a school-record 11 wins LY, WSU ret'd 13 st'rs but had to replace QB Minshew. WSU started 3-0 & led UCLA 49-17 late 3Q but would go on to lose 67-63 & lost 5 of their next 6 gms. Two wins over Stanford & Oreg St clinched WSU a bowl, but lost to UW for a 7th straight ssn to finish 6-6. WSU led the FBS in pass ypg (444 ypg) and QB Gordon led the FBS in pass yds (5228, 72%, 45-16) & the OFF gained 117 ypg more than what their foes all'd coming in (#8 FBS). WSU also had 7 diff players go over 500 yds rec & their OL all'd just 18 sks in 668 pass att (2.7%). After all'g 358 ypg LY, WSU's DEF gave up 457 ypg incl 494 ypg in conf play. Their DEF also all'd foes to gain 80 more ypg than their avg & their pass DEF is #116. AF was off B2B 5-7 ssn's, but ret'd 14 st'rs incl their QB and 4

AF was off B2B 5-7 ssn's, but ret'd 14 st'rs incl their QB and 4 of the top 6 rushers. AF upset Colorado on the road in Wk 2, but lost their lone MW gm the following week at Boise. A road loss to Navy 2 wks later dropped them to 3-2. AF closed out the ssn with 7 straight wins to finish 10-2 (6 wins by 14+ pts) with their lone test coming vs Army (won 17-13). AF finished the ssn #3 in rushing (293 ypg, 5.1 ypc) & had 3 players top 700 rush yds. AF's DEF was just as good, as they held foes to 96 ypg under their ssn avg (#12 FBS) & held teams to 108 rush ypg. AF also had 2 WR's top 600 yds for the 1st time this decade & QB Hammond passed for the most yds here s/ 15

There's a couple of factors pointing in the direction of Wazzu for this game. They need a win to secure a winning season. They are a 'dog against a G5 foe. We'll take the points. FORECAST: <u>WASHINGTON ST (+)</u> RATING: 1★

1st mtg. ISt is making their 1st appearance in this bowl & HC Campbell has the 'Clones in the post ssn a 3rd str ssn for the 1st time s/2000-'02. He's 1-1 SU/2-0 ATS at ISt. ND has had 3 str 10+ win ssn's but after making the Playoffs LY, not even making a NYD bowl is a disappointment & this is their 1st non-ranked bowl foe s/'13. This is ND's 9th bowl under HC Kelly, who is 3-5 SU/ATS here.

ISt entered '19 with B2B 8 win ssns, returned 16 starters, and were one of the most experienced in the nation. QB Purdy became the 1st QB to make it thru an entire ssn for the 'Clones s/'08! Despite the experience, ISt alternated wins & losses their F/5 gms. Following a ssn long 3 gm win streak, they were upset on Homecoming as DD chalk vs OKSt. Following a bye, the 'Clones nearly upset playoff bound Oklahoma, failing to convert a 2 pttry w/:24 left. After expected home wins over Texas & Kansas, ISt was held to a ssn low 236 yds in the ssn finale and lost at KSt by DD's. The 'Clones are #25 FBS on OFF, avg 64 ypg more than their opponents avg, and is #27 FBS on D, holding foes to 64 ypg less than their avg.

on D, holding foes to 64 yog less than their avg. After opening 2-0, #7 ND (+14') lost to #3 Georgia 23-17. They won their next 3 at home incl wins over #18 VS & USC. They were #8 when they were destroyed 45-14 at #19 Mich before winning their L/5 incl their L/4 ATS. The offense put up 40 ypg more than their opp allowed (#43) & was again led by QB Book (2787, 59%, 33-6), who was also their #2 rusher (516, 4.9, 4 td). The OL was solid paving the way for 4.9 ypc while allowing just 14 sks. The defense is impressive holding foes to 85 yds under their ssn avg (#15). They were #10 in pass eff D & had 30 sks led by DE Kareem (45 tkl, 5.5 sk, 4.5 tfl).

In bowls vs non-ranked foes s/08 ND is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS. The Irish will have the edge on OFF, DEF, & ST's. ISt HC Campbell has done a good job turning the program around, but may have a tough experience here against a very good Notre Dame team. FORECAST: NOTRE DAME RATING: 3★

FORECAST: NOTRE DAME RATING: 3★ 1st mtg. UM is bowling a 6th str yr & lost to WF 37-34 (-3) in LY's Birmingham Bowl. This is the Tigers 1st appearance in this bowl & they haven't won a bowl gm s/'14. HC Norvell left for Fla St & OL Cch Silverfield is the interim. PSt is bowling a 6th str ssn under HC Franklin & LY lost to KY in the Citrus Bowl 27-24 (-6). Franklin is 2-3 SU/3-2 ATS in bowls.

Despite having to replace both coord's following an 8 win ssn, UM was one of the pre-ssn favorites to represent the G5 in a NYD bowl and failed to disappoint. QB White followed up a 3,296 (63%, 26-9) '18 by throwing for 3,560 (64%, 33-9) this yr. RB Gainwell became the Tigers 3rd different 1,000 yd rusher the L3Y as UM enters #16 FBS on OFF, avg 75 ypg more than their opponents allow. The Tigers lone loss was by just two points at Temple as they were on the 2nd of B2B away games (+36 yds). UM enters the bowl on a 7 gm win streak by an avg of 16 ppg. The Tigers did benefit from an easy sked (#71) and were outgained in each of their L/2 gms vs Cincy.

PSt is a prime example of talent over experience. Despite being 1 of the least exp'd tms in the nation entering '19 and having to unexpectedly replace the QB they had penciled in as the st'r, HC Franklin has guided the Lions to DD wins for the 3rd time in 4Y. PSt began 8-0 incl a 3 wk stretch winning at lowa, vs UM & at MSt! Following a bye they were upset at Minny (+58 yds), but beat Indy before losing at Playoff bound OSt (-190 yds). The Lions closed the reg ssn by beating RU on Sr day. QB Clifford had better numbers than Trace McSorley, throwing for 2,521 (60%, 22-6). PSt held 4 opponents to ssn lows in ttl yds.

There's no doubt that UM will have a chip on their shoulder and will be fired up to play a P5 in what was supposed to be a NYD bowl, but it's being played on Dec 28th? While PSt won't be as motivated here, LY's bowl loss should have Franklin's tm prepared. FORECAST: PENN ST RATING: 1 ★



LSU is 4-0 SU in Peach Bowls, last ply'g here in '05. HC Orgeron is 2-1 SU/ATS in bowls. These two have met twice, both times in the Sugar Bowl with LSU winning in '04 and OU winning in 1950. 3rd str Playoff appearance for OU (0-2 SU/1-1 ATS) & 21st str bowl gm.

Áfter making the CFB Playoff in B2B vrs. ÓU again entered '19 as a Nat'l Title Contender, despite having to replace a Heisman winning QB for the 2nd str ssn. Bama grad trans Hurts took over the reins & picked up right where Mayfield & Murray left off. The Sooners began 7-0, outgaining all their opp's by 185+ yds. As 23' pt chalk at KSt w/a bye on deck, OU was stunned 48-41, suffering their lone loss (+71 yds). Following the bye the Sooners survived ISt by a pt on a missed 2 pt conv & trailed at BU 31-10 at HT, but came back & won on a 31 yd fg w/1:45 left (+218 yds). After an 18 pt Bedlam win to finish the reg ssn, OU beat BU in the B12 Champ gm (+168 yds). Hurts threw for 3,634 (72%, 32-7) & added 1,255 (5.7, 18 td) rush. The Sooners are #4 FBS on OFF avg 140 ypg more than their foes allow & are #11 on D, holding foes to 96 ypg less than their avg.

LSU is in a bowl for the 20th consec ssn and is making their 1st trip to the CFB Playoffs. LSU was the most experienced team in the SEC, with 16 returning starters back from a 10 win tm LY. Former NO Saints Asst Joe Brady helped revolutionize the LSU OFF. Heisman Winner Joe Burrow has thrown for an LSU school rec 4,715 (78% 48-6). LSU had 5 wins over teams that were ranked in the Top 10 at the time they played. The Tigers return to the site of the SEC Title gm where they beat UGA 37-10 (-7). LSU avg 554 ypg and is +213 ypg. Their OFF avg 190 ypg more than their foes allow. They allow 341 ypg and held their L/2 foes (A&M & UGA) to 228 ypg.

OU doesn't get credit for their DEF, but it's much improved this ssn & deserves every bit of their #24 ranking. The Sooners have the Playoff experience to keep this game closer than expected. FORECAST: OKLAHOMA (+) RATING: 2*

Clemson has reached a bowl every yr s/'04 & under HC Swinney they've reached 10+ wins 9 str yrs incl 5 str Playoffs. The Tigers are SU/ATS in the Semi-Finals incl a 31-0 (+2) win over OSt in '16. 3rd ssn making the Playoff for the Buckeyes (2-1 SU/ATS). This is the 7th Fiesta Bowl this decade for OSt (4-2 SU/5-1 ATS).

OSt rarely looked dominant in '18 and after future HOF HC Meyer ret'd, expectations weren't as high as usual in Columbus for '19. New HC Day proved to be the right man for the job as the Buckeyes became the 1st P5 tm in CFB history to run the table w/a 9 gm conf slate! OSt was the most complete tm in the nation, finishing #1 on OFF, avg 191 ypg more than their opponents allow, and #3 on D, holding foes to 145 ypg less than their avg. They feature not 1, but 2 Heisman finalists in QB Fields (2,953, 68%, 40-1) & DE Young (#1 FBS 16.5 sks). RB Dobbins is 171 yds shy of 2,000 rush! The

Buckeyes won by an avg of 36 ppg and outg'd their foes by 283 ypg. The Tigers are on a 27 gm win streak. Entering '19 they had 12 starters back incl QB Lawrence and were #50 in experience but they had to replace their entire Dline. Clemson started 4-0 easily but was nearly upset at NC when Tar Heels HC Brown elected to go for a 2 pt conversion and CU won 21-20 (-27'). The Tigers proceeded to destroy the rest of their competition by an avg score of 52-10 incl a 62-17 (-28') win vs UVA in the ACC Title. Their younger defense has posted better numbers than LY, holding foes to 248 ypg and 164 ypg less than their foes avg (#1 in FBS). Clemson is #2 in our pass eff D rankings. Clemson avg 531 ypg and 125 ypg more than foes allow (#5 in FBS). After some early season interception issues, QB Lawrence has a 19-0 ratio in his L/6

The Tigers are on an 18-3 ATS run, while OSt is on an 11-5 ATS run. Both teams really have no weaknesses & are superbly coached. Our checklist favors Ohio St so we'll take the points. FORECAST: OHIO ST (+)



Have met 15 times but last was in 1947! Broncos are ply'g their 5th bowl s/'14 (1-3 SU/ATS). WKU is playing in their 6th all-time bowl game and makes their first trip to the First Responder Bowl. WKU 3-2 SU/2-3 ATS all-time in bowl games.

With 17 str's back WM opened an expected 2-2 incl a 57-10 blowout of bowl bound Ga St. They opened MAC play 2-1 incl wins over CM & MU, who would play for the MAC Champ. After a loss to EM they won 3 str & needed to beat NIU to win the MAC West but lost. WM's offense has been it's strength as they avg 457 ypg & 48 ypg (#38) over their opp avg'd allowed. QB Wassink has been solid 2904, 59.8%, 19-7) but the star has been MAC POY RB Bellamy (1412, 5.7, 23 td). The OL has been strong paving the way for 5.4 ypc while allowing just 17 sks. The defense has struggled some as they are allowing foes 27 ypg (#89) over their ssn avg. That is surprising with the presence of MAC DPOY LB Hayward (132 tkl, 5 sk, 5.5 tfl) & that WM has 34 sks but WM is just #91 in pass eff D.

HC Helton took over a WKU squad that finished 3-9 in '18. The Toppers had 16 returning starters (#29 most exp'd) and added grad transfer QB Storey from Ark QB Duncan won the job in camp. WKU lost their opener to FCS Central Ark but rebounded with a WKU lost their opener to FCS Central Ark but rebounded with a road upset over FIU the following week. The 'Toppers were 1-2 when Duncan was inj'd & OFY. Storey took over and WKU won 7 of their L/9 games, with 4 more outright upsets and their 2 losses were close vs Marshall & FAU. WKU avg 380 ypg & they are +42 ypg against our #111 sked. QB Storey is compl'g 70% w/a 12-5 ratio. The 'Toppers defense holds foes 63 ypg below their avg (#29 in FBS). RB Walker has 1,115 (4.9) yds but WKU only avg 129 (3.8) rush ypg. WM has the edge on OFF, but WKU has the better DEF & ST's. Our checklist has this gm fairly even WKL is on a 3-7 ATS run as

These two met in '17's TaxSlayer Bowl and Miss St won 31-27 (+6'). Louisville has reached a bowl in Scott Satterfield's first season. The Cardinals had reached a bowl in 8 straight years until LY's 2-10 season. This is the 10th consec year that MSt has reached a bowl and 2nd under HC Moorhead. After winning 3 straight bowls, MSt lost to lowa in the LY's Outback Bowl 27-22 (-7).

Miss Stentered' 19 with 11 returning starters and they added grad transfer QB Tommy Stevens (Penn St). Stevens battled injuries and True frosh Garrett Shrader saw action in 8 games (4 st). After a 3-1 start, the Bulldogs went on a 4 game losing skid against Bowl foes, with all 4 losses by DD's. The Bulldogs won 3 of their L/4 incl in the Egg Bowl thanks to a missed PAT. MSt is 1-6 vs P5 bowl foes. The Bulldogs are +13 ypg on the season. They avg 403 ypg and 29 ypg more than their foes allow. Their defense holds foes 29 ypg below their avg. RB Hill led the SEC in rushing with 1,347 (5.7). MSt avg 292 rush ypg in their 6 wins and just 162 in their 6 losses.

The Cardinals were #14 in experience entering '19, but despite 16 starters back, most felt UL was in a rebuilding season and the Cardinals were picked for last by the ACC Media. UL was the surprise of the ACC, starting out 5-3 with wins over 4 bowl teams (WKU, BC, WF & UVA). After a blowout loss at Miami put bowl hopes in question, they beat NCSt and Cuse before losing to rival KY. RFr RB Hawkins rushed for 1,420 (5.9). QB Cunningham hit 61% w/a 20-5 ratio (401, 3.8 rush). The Cardinals avg 71 ypg more than their foes allow (#17 in FBS). Their defense allowed over 500 yds in 6 of their L/9. UL has allowed 211 (5.5) rush ypg and they've allowed 56 ypg more than their foes avg (#107 in FBS).

MSt has only covered 2 of their L/8, but needs a win here to secure a winning season. UL struggles stopping the run and 'Dogs RB Hill should be able to run free and wild! FORECAST: <u>MISSISSIPPI ST</u> RATING: 2★

IL is 7-3 SU in the series & Cal won the L/mtg 35-20 (-21') in '05. This is the 2nd Redbox Bowl, previously known as the Foster Farms, Kraft Fight Hunger, Emerald & SF Bowl. IL is bowling for the 1st time s/'14 & this is HC Smith's 1st postssn appearance. Cal HC Wilcox lost his lone bowl LY in OT vs TCU 10-7 (-1).

Despite entering '19 with their most exp'd squad yet under HC Smith, IL had low expectations after losing 6 of 7 to end '18 (avg loss by 31 ppg). After a 2-0 start, the Illini dropped 4 str, including at home vs EM. On HC vs UW, IL trailed 20-7 late 3Q, but hit the GW 39 yd fg w/no time left, which led to a 4 gm win streak, incl outright upsets at PU & at MSt. Following a bye, the Illini dropped their L/2 gms, the most surprising a 29-10 (-7') loss vs NW on Sr day (-273 yds). IL is #106 FBS on OFF, avg 52 ypg less than their foes allow, & is #104 on D, all'g 51 ypg more than their opponents avg. The Illini enter with their best TO margin s/'99!

Coming into the ssn Cal brought back just 11 strs (lost top 4 WR's, top RB) after going 7-6 & making a bowl LY. Cal started the ssn 4-0 incl wins at Wash & Ole Miss. QB Garbers (1500, 59%, 10-3) would get inj'd vs ASU & miss 4 gms (Cal went 1-3). With Garbers back Cal lost to USC then beat Stanford & UCLA to get to 7-5. Cal avg'd just 323 yds on OFF & that dipped to 299 ypg vs P12 foes. Cal had the #1 pass eff D LY & despite returning all 4 strs in the secondary, they dropped to #40 (262 pass ypg all'd, 15-7 ratio). LB Weaver led the FBS in tkl's (173 tkl, 10 tfl) & was P12 DPO. Over the L/4 gms Cal's run DEF stiffened up & all'd just 48 ypg (1.9 ypc). Overall Cal's DEF held tms to 22 ppg & 34 ypg under their ssn avg.

IL needs to force TO's in order to remain competitive, but Cal does a great job in taking care of the football. The Bears have a big advantage on the defensive side of the ball and QB Garbers should be back to 100% healthy by the time this game kicks off. FORECAST: CALIFORNIA BATING: 1★

FORECAST: CALIFORNIA RATING: 1★ This is UVA's 3rd str bowl for the first time since '98-'00 under HC Mendenhall. UVA shutout SC 28-0 (+4) in the Belk Bowl LY for their first bowl win since '05. Mendenhall is 7-6 SU/ATS in bowls going back to his days at BYU. HC Mullen has led UF to B2B Bowls. UF won the only prev mtg in 1959. LY the Gators beat Mich in the Peach Bowl 41-15 (+4'). The Gators have won 9 of their L/12 Bowl gms.

UVA entered' 19 with 14 starters back (#56 in experience) incl QB Perkins. The 'Hoos started the season 4-0 before losing road games at ND & Miami. They suffered significant injuries in their secondary but still managed to win 5 of their next 6 games incl a 39-30 (+2 upset over VT to end their 15Y losing streak in the Commonwealth Cup. They were tied 7-7 early vs Clemson but couldn't stop the Tigers offense and lost 63-17 (+27'), though they did finish with the most yards Clemson has allowed all year with 387. UVA avg 390 ypg and is +32 ypg on the season. They hold foes 26 ypg below their avg (#53 in FBS). QB Perkins has an 18-11 ratio and also leads UVA in rushing with 745 (3.5). The 'Hoos banged up secondary has allowed over 310 pass yards in 4 of their L/5.

In HC Dan Mullen's 2nd ssn, UF 13 returning starters from a 10 win team. The Gators started the ssn 6-0 and led LSU 28-21 3Q before allowing 21 unanswered and was only outgained by 54 yds. The Gators lost by a td vs Georgia before winning their L3 gms by 35 ppg. The Gators are +122 ypg vs FBS foes. QB Trask took over for Feleipe Franks after an injury and finished with a 24-6 ratio (68%). The Gators allow 82 ypg less than their foes avg (#14 in FBS). DE Greenard leads the SEC with 9 sks. Florida has our #24 pass eff D.

Florida is 5-1 ATS vs FBS non-conf foes under Mullen. If you take a look at the checklist to the left, the Gators have an advantage in nearly every category. HC Mullen has no problem running up the score vs inferior foes and we have a feeling that's what will happen. FORECAST: FLORIDA RATING: 2★



ST Ban

VT's 27 year active bowl streak is the longest in the nation. This is VT's 4th bowl under Justin Fuente (1-2 ATS). They've lost their L/2 bowls. Fuente is 2-2 SU/3-1 ATS in Bowls since his time at Memphis. VT last played in the Music City Bowl in 1998 when they beat Alabama 38-7 (-5). KY is also playing in their 4th consec bowl. This is their 6th Music City Bowl since 1999 (2-3 SU/ATS).

HC Stoops has led KY to 4 straight winning seasons incl 10 wins LY but this is by far his best coaching job. The 'Cats entered '19 with just 10 starters back and were #105 in experience then they lost QB Wilson for the season. Lynn Bowden led in receiving through the F/5 games then was moved to QB and the 'Cats switched to an option based offense. Bowden topped 100 rush yds in 6 of the L/7. KY avg'd 352 rush ypg in their L/7 and went 5-2 with Bowden at QB. The Cats held 5 of their L/6 foes under 300 yds incl UGA to 270. KY allows 56 ypg less than their foes avg (#31 in FBS). The 'Cats are 4-4 SU/6-2 vs bowl elig foes.

VT barely kept their bowl streak alive in '18 but returned in '19 much more experienced, with 16 returning starters (#42 most exp'd). The Hokies upset BC in the opener but had unimpressive wins against ODU & FCS Furman before getting blowout by Duke 45-10 (-2). The Hokies switched to QB Hooker and they won 6 of their next 7 games, only losing to ND 21-20 (+17') when Hooker missed with an inj. VT posted BZB shutouts against GT and Pitt. They needed a win over UVA to reach the ACC Title game but had their 15Y Commonwealth Cup streak broken. The Hokies avg 427 ypg and are +74 ypg when Hooker starts. The Hokies avg 173 (3.9) rush ypg on the ssn and when Hooker starts they avg 197 rush ypg (4.2).

KY is on a 6-0 SU/ATS run vs non-conf foes. This will be VT DC Foster's last game & it's safe to say he knows a thing or 2 about how to defend the option. We'll side with the Hokies in a close game. FORECAST: VIRGINIA TECH RATING: 1*

1st mtg s/1984 (FSU is 3-1 vs ASU) & met in the 1971 Fiesta Bowl. Herm Edwards reached a bowl LY in year 1 but lost to Fresno St. ASU is in the Sun Bowl for a 7th time (3-2-1 SU) & last played here in '17 against NCSt (lost 52-31). Interim HC Haggins led FSU to a bowl in '17 when he replaced Jimbo Fisher and they crushed Miss 42-13 (-16'). FSU's 36 year bowl streak was snapped LY.

After having their 36 year bowl streak snapped, FSU had 16 starters back in '19 and were expected to be vastly improved. The Noles led Boise St 31-13 2Q when things started to unravel. They let the Broncos rally for the victory, then needed a missed PAT to beat ULM and lost at UVA. After winning B2B home ACC games they lost B2B ACC road gms. The Noles were 4-4 when they lost at home to Miami 27-10 (-3) which led to HC Taggart's firing. For the 2nd time in 3Y Interim HC Haggins rallied the troops and got FSU bowl elig. FSU avg 403 ypg and is -33 ypg on the season. The Noles have allowed over 300 pass yds on 4 occasions and is #65 in our pass eff D rankings.

After a 7-6 ssn in year 1 under Herm Edwards, ASU ret'd 15 strs but had to replace an AA receiver & a 3-year starting QB. ASU opened the ssn 5-1 incl a road win at Mich St, but would drop the next 4 gms to P-12 foes, with 3 of the losses being by 10 pts or less. ASU ended strong w/a 31-28 upset over Oregon & a win over rival Ariz. True frosh QB Daniels was efficient (2748, 62%, 17-2) & WR Aiyuk filled in as ASU's top target (1192, 8 td).RB Benjamin rushed for just 1,083 (4.3, 10 td) after rushing for 1,642 (5.5, 16 td) last ssn & will miss the bowl (NFL). ASU's run D held foes to 117 ypg (3.4 ypc) & overall they held teams to 27 ypg below their ssn avg.

FSU plays hard for interim HC Haggins & the returning plyr's should want to leave a positive impression for incoming HC Norvell. That has us leaning with the 'Noles to keep this gm closer than expected. FORECAŠT: FLORIDA ST (+) RATING: 1*


1st mtg. KSt ply'd in this bowl in '15, losing to Ark 45-23 (+13) Navy has 1 appearance in this bowl, falling to Ohio St by 3 in 81 & ply'd here earlier TY, losing 35-23 (+10') vs Memphis. HC Klieman is cch'g his 1st bowl, but has plenty of postssn exp. Navy is bowling for the 7th time in 8Y & is on a 4-1 SU/5-0 ATS run in the postssn.

LY KSt failed to make a bowl for the 1st time s/'09 & legendary HOF HC Snyder ret'd. New HC Klieman won 4 FCS Nat'l Titles in 5Y & benefitted from a highly experienced tm coming back for '19. The Cats got off to a fast start, going 3-0 incl a road win at SEC Miss St. After losses in their F/2 B12 gms by DD's, KSt rebounded w/3 str wins incl handing eventual playoff bound OU their lone defeat! They then fell at TX on the 2nd of B2B road gms before a surprising home loss vs WV (+102 yds). The 'Cats closed out the ssn w/B2B outright upsets. While the OFF has struggled, ranking just #108 FBS, avg 54 ypg less than their opp's allow, the D is #32 FBS, holding foes to 61 ypg less than their avg. ST's, always a stalwart under Snyder, remains top notch (#3 FBS)

Navy's 3 wins in '18 was their fewest s/'02 & they failed to make a bowl for the 1st time s/'11. They made a change at DC and despite just 8 ret str's (academies are usually lightly exp'd) a rebound was expected. The Middles won 6 of their F/7, with their lone loss at eventual AAC Champ Memphis (+72 yds). Following a bye they lost at N Dame before winning 3 str to close out the ssn, including beating arch rival Army for the 1st time s/ 15 & claiming the CIC Trophy. QB Perry has 1804 (6.8) rush yds & Navy is #29 FBS on OFF avg 60 ypg more than their foes allow & is #15 on DEF, holding foes to 89 og less than their avg (held 4 foes to ssn lows in yds).

KSt HC Klieman & his staff has experience defending the option and with weeks to prepare will have the players ready as well. Our checklist leans with the 'Cats so we'll gladly take the points.

First ever mtg. This is the 5th Arizona Bowl & the first trip here for both tms. GSt is in their 3rd bowl as an FBS team, losing the Cure Bowl in '15 & winning the Cure Bowl in '17. WY reached 6+ wins for the 4th straight ssn (missed bowl LY at 6-6) so this is 3rd bowl for WY under HC Bohl (2-0 ATS).

GSt was off a down 2-10 ssn, but ret'd 14 st'rs & were in year 3 under HC Elliott. GSt started the ssn with a big upset over Tennessee (38-30) then beat an FCS foe, but losses to WMich & TXSt dropped (38-30) then beat an PCS toe, but losses to Winich & LSS dropped them to 2-2. GSt then won 4 straight gms incl a 28-21 win over Army. GSt QB Ellington tore his ACL vs ULM, but continued to play, yet GSt lost 3 of their L/4 gms. Before the inj to Ellington, GSt avg'd 275 rush yds (5.5 ypc) but after avg'd just 157 yds (4.2 ypc), but they finished the ssn #14 in the FBS w/ 245 rush ypg. RB Barnett set a school record w/1,389 rush yds (6.0, 12 td). GSt's DEF was their weakness this sen as they all'd 450 ymg & 36 png and all'd foe to weakness this ssn, as they all'd 450 ypg & 36 ppg and all'd foes to gain 48 more ypg than their ssn avg (#101 FBS). Their run D gave up 212 ypg (5.3 ypc) and their pass eff D was ranked #125.

WY came into '19 with just 11 ret st'rs & had to replace a 1,300 yd rusher & 3 st'rs on the DL. QB Chambers & RB Valladay sparked the OFF over the F/8 gms (239 rush ypg) & WY got out to a 6-2 mark before Chambers was OFY (knee). That loss hurt WY as the offense avg'd just 281 yds & 15 pts over the L/4 gms and dropped 3 of their L/4 gms to finish 7-5. The WY rush DEF was stout all ssn, holding tms to 99 rush yds (2.8 ypc) & overall held teams to 24 ypg below their ssn avg. WY also had 31 sks this ssn, up from 19 last ssn. WY's pass D is also ranked #WY has the #48. WY has the #125 pass OFF (128 ypg) and all'd 20 sks, but WY avg'd 210 rush ypg & RB Valladay was #2 in the MW with 1,061 rush yds

GSt QB Elington's inj hampers the OFF a great deal and WY's already solid DEF will look even more potent.

FORECAST: WYOMING

RATING: 4* This is the 27th Alamo Bowl. Only prior mtg was in '82 which Tex

won 21-12. This is Texas' 4th trip here. They won in '12 & '06 but lost their most recent in '13 vs Oregon 30-7. Tom Herman is 3-1 SU/ ATS all-time in bowls incl 2-0 here. This is Utah's first trip here, but Utah HC Whittingham is an incredible 11-2 SU (9-4 ATS) in bowls, but had their 5 gm win streak snapped LY vs NW.

Following their outright upset over UGA in LY's Sugar Bowl, QB Ehlinger famously stated, "We're back" and Texas had Nat'l Title hopes entering '19. Despite being near the bottom in terms of returning experience and with just 8 str's back, the talent remained. The 'Horns began the ssn by winning 4 of their F/5 with the lone loss by only a td vs eventual playoff #1 LSU. Inj's decimated the secondary and Texas failered down the stretch, losing 4 of their L/7. The Horns did get a blowout in their ssn finale, beating Tx Tech by 25. QB Ehlinger leads an OFF that is #12 FBS, avg 88 ypg more than their opponents allow on avg, but the D is #80, all'g 15 ypg more than their foes avg. Utah brought back 14 st'rs from a team that finished 9-5 & made

the P-12 title gm a ssn ago. Utah went 3-0 in non-conf play before losing the P-12 opener at USC 30-23. In their final eight P-12 reg ssn gms Utah would assert themselves as the P-12's best team ssn gms Utan Would assert inemselves as the P-12's best team, holding those 8 tms to 225 ypg & 9.5 ppg, winning by an avg of 29 pts (only close gm vs Wash, 33-28). But in the P-12 title gm they fell to Oreg 37-15 (all'd 432 yds). QB Huntley (2966, 73%, 19-4) & RB Moss (1359, 6.2, 15 td) led a Utah OFF that avg'd 443 yds & 34 pts. But the Utes DEF was their strength, holding tms to 159 ypg under their ssn avg (#2 FBS) & held tms to 70 rush yds (#1 FBS). Their pass eff D finished the ssn ranked #3.

HC Willingham has been excellent in bowl games but Tom Herman is 15-4 as an underdog with 10 outright upsets. Utah will be disappointed to be playing here while Texas will be hungry for an upset. FORECAST: TEXAS (+)

RATING: 4★

This is the 75th Citrus Bowl. This series is tied 2-2. Bama won the L/mtg '12 but Mich is 2-1 in bowls vs the Tide. Mich is bowling for 5th str year under Harbaugh (1-3 SU/ATS). The Wolverines are 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS here. Bama has been to a bowl 16 str years incl 13 under Saban. Saban is just 2-2 SU/ATS at Bama in bowls that aren't Playoff/Nat'I Titles. Bama last ply'd here in '10 and beat Mich St 49-7 (-8)

UM had extremely high expectations entering the ssn with HC Harbaugh in his 5Y and 13 ret str's incl 8 on OFF. The Wolve's got off a 2-0 start, but were then shockingly blown out at UW (-188 yds). After 3 str wins, UM lost at PSt despite having a +134 yd edge. The Wolve's rebounded with a blowout win vs N Dame and entered 'The Game' on a 4 gm win streak. Unfortunately, UM lost against their arch rival for the 15th time in 16Y, getting blown out by 29 (-181 yds). QB Patterson was slow to pick up the new OFF, but has thrown for 300+ in 3 str gms into the bowl and the Wolve's are #7 FBS on D, holding opponents to 110 ypg below their avg. The Tide had just 12 starters back in '19 and were #86 in experience

but HC Saban was used to replacing talent so the Tide still started the ssn ranked #2. Bama then lost 2 starting LB's in August. The Tide still started 8-0 (avg MOV 32 ppg) but the defense was exposed by LSU in a 46-41 loss (559 yds were most all'd since '14 Iron Bowl). QB Tagovailoa was knocked OFY vs Miss St and Bama dropped the Iron Bowl 48-45 (-3') despite a +161 yd edge. Bama avg 527 ypg in their L/4 despite Tua's injury and RB Harris stepped up with 112 ypg (319 ypg all'd) but they still hold foes 69 ypg below their avg (#22 in (FBS). Only 4 of Bama's 10 wins have come over bowl foes (3-1 ATS). After reaching the CFB Playoffs 5 str years we wonder if Bama

will be fully focused on a less meaninful game while Mich will be hungry to pull an upset over an SEC giant so we will take the points. FORECAST: MICHIGAN (+) RATING: 2*

1st mtg. MN has reached a bowl 2 straight years under HC Fleck. LY they won the Quick Lane Bowl over GT 34-10 (+5'). HC Malzahn has led Auburn to a bowl in all 7 seasons but they've only won 2 of them. LY Auburn crushed Purdue 56-7 (-3') in the first half.

MN st'd 8 frosh in LY's bowl win & entered '19 full of exp, with 18 ret str's. Following a 6-0 start, the Gophers were ranked for the 1st time s/'14. They followed that up with 3 more wins, including an outright upset vs PSt (-58 yds). MN lost their 1st game the following wk at lowa (+141 yds), but rebounded with a win at NW. With a trip to their 1st ever B10 Champ gm on the line vs Wisc, the Gophers lost by 3 td's (-81 yds) on Sr day. QB Morgan took over as the str mid ssn in '18 & threw for 2,975 (66%, 28-6) in '19. RB Smith leads a deep corps & enters with 1,094 (5.2) as MN is #24 FBS on OFF, avg 65 ypg more than their opponents allow.

Auburn had 14 starters returning in '19 (#58 in exp) but had to replace their 2Y starting QB. True Frosh Bo Nix won the job in camp. The Tigers trailed Oregon for nearly the entire game in their opener until Nix threw a td pass with :09 left. Auburn was 5-0 until they lost 3 of their next 5 at Florida (-3 TO's), at LSU by just a fg (outgained 508-287) and vs Georgia (held 329-251 yd edge). The Tigers ended the season with a home upset in the Iron Bowl 48-45 (+3') despite getting outgained 515-354. Aub is +97 ypg. Their defense is led by DT Brown (Bednarik/Outland/Nagurski Finalist). They hold foes 94 ypg below their avg (#8 in FBS). Nix is completing 57% (15-6).

AU is on a 10-3 overall ATS run. While the Tigers have the edge on OFF, DEF & ST's, we do give MN slight edges in the position categories featuring QB, RB & WR to the left on the checklist. We are really impressed by the job that HC Fleck has done with the Gophers, but they did benefit from playing a weak sked, while AU has been battle tested more frequently & that could be the difference. FORECAST: <u>AUBURN</u> RATING: 1★

The "Granddaddy of them all" is college football's oldest bowl game (first played in 1902). These tms last mtg was in this gm back in '12 when UO won an offensive slugfest 45-38. This is UW's 18th str bowl gm & they've won 5 in a row SU. UO is making their 8th trip here (3-4) & first since '15. HC Cristobal is 1-1 SU in bowls here.

After an uncharacteristic 8 win ssn LY (broke streak of 4 str DD win ssns) UW entered '19 wanting to prove '18 was the outlier & despite just 12 ret str's, did just that. The Badgers raced out to a 6-0 start, winning each by over a td. With a trip to Ohio St on deck, UW lost at IL in a gm they led by DD's late 3Q (+105 yds). The Badgers trailed the Buckeye's by 10 at HT, but were blown out in the 2H (-240 yds). UW then ended the reg ssn with 4 str wins, including at MN by 3 td's in a gm that decided the B10 West. In a rematch vs Ohio St in the B10 Champ gm, the Badgers led 21-7 at HT, but were shutout in the 2H and lost 34-21. RB Taylor is 91 yds shy of B2B 2,000+ rush yd ssns & QB Coan is completing 70% (17-4). UW is #5 FBS on D, holding foes to 117 ypg less than their avg.

UO brought back 17 strs from LY's 9-4 squad incl QB Herbert who turned down the NFL. UO's ssn started w/a last-sec loss to Auburn, but won their next 9 gms by an avg of 26 pts (only 2 close gms vs Wash & WSU). UO then got upset by ASU before beating rival Oreg St. In the P-12 title gm UO put up 432 yds & 37 pts on a Utah tm that came in all'g 242 ypg & 11 ppg. Herbert improved as a passer (67%, 32-5) while RB Verdell topped 1,000 yds again (1171, 6.5, 8 td). UO's DEF was a big key to their success, holding tms to 78 ypg below their ssn avg (#19 FBS) while their pass eff D was #4 & their

41 sks (true frosh Thibodeaux led w/ 9 sks) were tops in the P-12. This is an intriguing matchup between two evenly matched programs. Our checklist has this gm dead even and with that being said, we'll take the 'dog in a gm that figures to go down to the wire. FORECAST: OREGON (+) RATING: 2★

The Bears are bowling for the 9th time in 10Y & this is their 1st appearance here sl'56! They beat Vandy 45-38 (+4) in LY's Texas Bowl & HC Rhule is 1-1 SU/ATS. UGA is in their 2nd str Sugar Bowl. LY they lost to TX 28-21 (-12). The Dawgs are 4-6 SU all-time in the Sugar Bowl. UGA is 4-0 SU vs BU, but the last mtg was '89. HC Smart is 2-2 SU/3-1 ATS in bowls.

Despite being less exp'd than LY, the Bears were confident heading into the '19 ssn as HC Ruhle had guided Temple to DD wins by his 3rd season. BU reeled off 9 straight wins to begin the season after surviving 3OT at TCU. The following week vs Oklahoma the Bears led 31-10 at HT, but couldn't hold on and lost their 1st game (-218 yds). BU then won B2B games to make it to the B12 Title game in a rematch with the Sooners. Despite again leading at the half, the Bears were down to their 3rd string QB and couldn't hold on once again (-168 yds). QB Brewer should be able to return (CS). The Bears went from #73 on D LY, to #29 this year, holding opponents to 64 ypg less than their avg.

UGA had 12 returning starters in '19 incl QB Fromm from an 11 win team last year (#38 most exp'd). The Dawgs started the season 5-0. Fromm threw 5 int's all season, and all 5 came in just 2 gms incl 3 at SC where they held a 468-297 yd edge but lost in OT. The Dawgs won their next 6 games, incl close wins over UF, Aub & A&M. In the SEC Title gm UGA was held to just 61 rush yds and lost 37-10 (+7). The Dawgs avg 410 ypg but were held under 300 yds in 3 of the L/4 and they've been held under 30 points in 7 of their L/8. UGA holds foes 133 ypg below their avg (#4 in FBS). QB Fromm is completing 60% but just 47% in his L/5.

BU is superb as a dog, covering 8 in row with 6 outright wins! UGA has struggled over the last month of the ssn so we have no problem taking the points in this matchup.




