## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ INDIANA over Michigan St** - The home team is on a 1-5 SU/0-6 ATS run in this series. Indy continues to deliver for us as we won our OCT 5★ GOM on the Hoosiers last week and also won a 3★ selection on these pages! IND did get held to a ssn-low 312 yds, but held Wash to a ssn-low 318 yds and got a key pick-six in their 31-17 win. MSU did hold Mich to 265 yds but lost 24-17 last week. IND could get QB Rourke (75%, 15-3) back this week (thumb inj) and that would be a boost for this offense. Their offense puts up 120 ypg more than their foes allow (#7 FBS!). IND gets it done on defense to, allowing just 270 ypg and holding foes to 69 ypg under their ssn avg. IND does have the #25 pass D (62%, 7-9) and MSU QB Chiles has just a 7-10 ratio on the ssn. Against powerful offensive tms (Ohio St, Oregon) MSU allowed 483 and 477 yds plus 38 and 31 pts respectively. Their OL gave up 9 sks vs those 2 power tms & IND has 24 sks on the season, plus only allow 86 rush ypg (3.0). IND has won every game by 14+ pts and are laying just over a td here, so we have no problem going back to a team that is 8-0 SU/ATS on the season! **FORECAST: INDIANA by 20**

**3★ NEBRASKA over UCLA** - Nebraska enters this game still in search of that elusive 6th win and are off B2B games vs top B10 foes Indiana and Ohio St. After losing 56-7 vs Indy they went to OSU and nearly pulled the upset, losing just 21-17 and holding OSU to 218 yds under their season avg! This has been a rebuilding year for UCLA, as they sit at just 2-5 and their 2 wins are by 3 pts each. UCLA's offense is only avg'g 302 ypg/17 ppg, which includes just 65 rush ypg (2.5). While UCLA did find offense in their last game at Rutgers (478 yds) this Nebraska Def is much tougher as they have allowed just 302 ypg and if you take out the Indiana game (495 yds) they have allowed just 274 ypg. UCLA's OL has allowed 20 sks (8.8%) and the strong Nebraska pass rush has 22 sks this ssn (9.4%). At home this season Nebraska is +92 ypg/+16 ppg and with the line under a td we love the Huskers to get a dominant victory here! **FORECAST: NEBRASKA by 17**

**3★ SOUTH CAROLINA over Texas A&M** - Home team is 3-0 SU and SC has covered the last two. Gamecocks are 4-3 and fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they had a 21-0 lead on Oklahoma five minutes into the game with 2 defensive tds and won 35-9. Gamecocks are +49 ypg on the season with close losses to LSU and Bama on the road. A&M lost their opener to Notre Dame and have won 7 straight since. Last week A&M trailed LSU 17-7 when they switched to dual threat QB Marcel Reed. The defense forced 2 TO's for short field td's A&M pulled away for a 38-23 (-1) win. Reed only had to throw 2 passes as LSU was clearly unprepared to deal with a dual threat QB. SC has a fast/explosive Dline led by Kyle Kennard and true frosh Dylan Stewart. They have 28 sacks including 9 against Oklahoma 2 weeks ago. With a full week to prepare for Reed, and a superior Dline to bottle up the athletic QB in front of a fired up home crowd in a night game, we can't help but like South Carolina to pull the upset. **FORECAST: SOUTH CAROLINA by 7**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Colorado St over NEVADA** - Since Jay Norvell left Nev to take the HC job at Colo St in 2022, the Rams are 2-0 SU vs Nevada. CSU is riding a 3-game win streak coming into this matchup as the offense has played much better since the bye week, avg'g 409 ypg. Nev is 0-3 in MW play after their 21-pt loss to Hawaii last week where QB Lewis did not play and it was backups Purdy & Bianco who played last week. Lewis remains a ? for this game. Nev is allowing 174 rush ypg (4.6) the L/4 gms and takes on a CSU rush attack, led by Avery Morrow (711, 6.3), that is avg'g 190 ypg (5.1) over the L/4 games. CSU QB Fowler-Nicolosi started off with a 2-4 ratio in the Rams F/4 gms, but over the L/4 gms has a 5-1 ratio and is hitting 63% despite CSU losing their top WR Horton to inj. The Rams OL has also done a solid job in pass pro, allowing just 8 sks on the season incl 0 sacks the L/2 gms. The line is right around even and we feel the Rams are the better team here and win by over a td. **FORECAST: Colorado St by 9**

**2★ CLEMSON over Louisville** - Clemson has owned this series, winning all 8 ACC meetings and they've covered the last 6. Since their loss to Georgia in the opener, Clemson has won 6 straight by an avg score of 48-21 (+209 ypg). UL is 5-3 SU but on an 0-5 ATS run. Last week they trailed 20-0 at BC then rallied to win by 4 but were -7. Clemson's D allows 349 ypg but Swinney has used his backups often in blowouts and they've allowed garbage td's against NCSU (3x), Stanford & UVA. UL's D allows 359 ypg but have given up 447 ypg in their L/4 while Clemson has all'd 298 ypg in their L/4. UL does have a fantastic RB in Isaac Brown (649, 7.5) but Clemson has allowed just 59 rush ypg (2.2) in their last 3 games. UL is +101 ypg but only -18 vs ACC while Clemson is +181 vs the ACC. Clemson is a hot team and we will go with the Tigers for a dominant victory! **FORECAST: CLEMSON by 20**

## OTHER GAMES

### WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 30th

**LIBERTY by 4 over Jacksonville St** - Last year this game was tied 10-10 at half and Jax St had a 212-165 yd edge then Liberty controlled the 2H and won 31-13 (-6'). Liberty struggled as a large favorite all year and are off a shocking loss to Kennesaw St. Chadwell has saved QB Salter's legs this year. He rushed for 1,089 (6.7) last year but only 278 (4.6) this year. Jax St started 0-3 but has won their last 4 by 35 ppg and +240 ypg but those were against the 3 worst teams in CUSA and Southern Miss (comb'd record of 3-23 vs FBS). Jax St QB Tyler Huff is hitting 65% with an 8-4 ratio and is their #2 rusher with 654 (7.0). Jax St is rushing for 357 (6.9) in their last 4 but Liberty has allowed just 114 (3.2) this season. While Jax St is clearly playing better, we think a big game like this is exactly what Liberty needs to wake up and don't be surprised if we see Salter used more in the run game. Jax St has losses to Coastal and EMich. We will take the Flames to win.

**WKU by 31 over Kennesaw St** - First meeting. Kennesaw St is off their first ever win as an FBS member, shocking Liberty as 28 point underdogs 27-24. Prior to that win KSU was 0-6 and -20 ppg/-177 ypg. Unlike Liberty, WKU has no problem dispatching weaker foes. They already have three wins by 24 points or more this year. The 'Toppers are fresh off a bye and upset Sam Houston 31-14 (+2) two weeks ago. WKU is +93 ypg in CUSA play including a 28 point win at Middle Tennessee who beat KSU 14-5 earlier this year. WKU QB Caden Veltkamp has a 14-5 ratio. The Toppers are putting up 401 ypg and average 13 ypg more than their foes allow. KSU put up a ssn high 323 yards last week but still only avg's 242 ypg and are held 128 ypg below what their opponents allow which is worst in the country. Hard to see how KSU can keep up so we have a strong lean on WKU.

### Thursday OCTOBER 31st

**Tulane vs CHARLOTTE** - First meeting between AAC foes. Tulane is 6-2 SU/5-2-1 ATS and their only losses were to Kansas St and Oklahoma, both closer than expected. CLT is 3-5 SU/4-4 ATS this year. The 49ers led Memphis 28-24 4Q last week but lost by 5. They are -69 ypg on the season but only -8 in AAC play with wins over Rice and East Carolina. Tulane does have the edge in all 3 phases and Jon Sumrall is 14-1-1 ATS on the road while Tulane is on a 12-1 SU/11-2-1 ATS run on the road as well. CLT is 4-10 as a home dog. Tulane is off a misleading 8 point win at

North Texas where they led 21-3 1Q and 45-24 4Q. Tulane is currently laying over 2 td's and Buff Poggi is 6-2 ATS as a double-digit dog. Call 1-800-654-3448 or goto NCSports.com to get our Thursday College Marquee for \$15.

### Friday NOVEMBER 1st

**UCONN by 13 over Georgia St** - Georgia St won the only prior meeting last year 35-14 (-3). This is UConn's 6th straight at home where they are 5-1 SU/4-1-1 ATS this year after beating Rice 17-10 (-7) last week. The Huskies had a 309-178 yd edge and Rice's only td was a 100 yd KR in the 4Q. Georgia St has lost four straight games and are -9 ppg/-35 ypg on the season. On the road they are -15 ppg and -77 ypg. They switched to former Akron/GTech QB Zach Gibson who threw for 192 and a td last week vs App State in a 33-26 (+7) loss. UConn QB Joe Fagnano has an 11-3 ratio. The Huskies have the edge in all 3 phases though Georgia St has played the tougher sked (#85 vs #123). Mora is 11-6-1 ATS at home and a win makes the Huskies bowl eligible so our lean is with the home team.

**FAU by 3 over Usf** - FAU has won the last two meetings including last year 56-14 (+2'). USF is 3-4 and fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they beat UAB 35-25 (-13') but was outgained 485-355. FAU is just 2-5 and is also fresh off a bye. The Owls lost two straight prior to their bye and were held to a ssn low 203 yards in their 38-24 (+6') loss at UTSA two weeks ago. Both teams have had inconsistent play at QB. FAU's Cam Fancher is hitting 61% but only a 5-6 ratio while FAU's QB Brown has been hurt and bkp QB Bryce Archie has a 3-4 ratio. USF has played the tougher sked (#64 vs #108) and has a huge ST's edge (#12 vs #116). It's hard to have confidence the way both teams have played but Tom Herman is 22-10 ATS as a dog so we will take FAU to win.

**BOISE ST by 27 over San Diego St** - SDSSt has covered 7 of the 9 meetings as MW foes since 2011. Last season Boise (-6') allowed a td with :42 4Q for the backdoor cover (won 34-31). SDSSt has gotten better on offense the L/4 gms (364 ypg, 25 ppg) and their pass rush has collected 17 sks the L/4 gms. However they take on a Boise team that holds foes to 27 ypg under their avg and they lead the FBS in sacks (34). Boise does also have star RB Jeanty (1376, 8.7, 18 td) and SDSSt does have a solid run D (160, 4.0) but have given up some rush yds to Oreg St (237, 4.6) and Cal (275, 6.5). Boise overall puts up 97 ypg more than their foes and at home are +156 ypg while SDSSt is -100 ypg on the road. Boise is on a 5-0-1 ATS run and is 3-0 ATS at home this season, so we don't mind leaning with them laying over 3 td's here.

### SATURDAY November 2nd

**Virginia Tech by 7 over GEORGIA TECH** - VT has lost their last two trips to the JMA Wireless Dome (formerly Carrier Dome). These two met last year and VT won 38-10 in Blacksburg on a Thurs Night. Hokies have won 3 straight and are on a 4-0 ATS run. VT's 21-6 (-10') win over GTech last week was their closest win in the last two years but they were held to a ssn low 233 yards and were -123 yds. Cuse is off a rough performance at Pitt where QB Kyle McCord threw 5 int's and 3 were returned for td's in a 41-13 loss. McCord had a 19-6 ratio coming into that game and now faces our #26 ranked pass D, allowing just 54% and DE Antaun Powell-Ryland has 11 sacks this year. Both teams need a win to get to a bowl. Syracuse didn't play a single home game in October but VT led Miami by double-digits at Miami earlier this year and blew out Stanford 31-7 on the road while Cuse lost to Stanford at home. Cuse is dangerous but we like VT to win by a td.

**APPALACHIAN ST by 3 over Old Dominion** - Last season App St (-5') was at ODU but was upset 28-21 as ODU scored the GW td with :48 left 4Q. App St is off a 33-26 win vs GA State, but are just 3-4 on the season, while ODU is 3-1 in SBC play and last Thur beat GA Southern 47-19 where they put up 560 yds. ODU does have the #77 pass D (62%, 12-10) and App St QB Aguilar had his best game of the season last week, throwing for 299 yds and a 3-0 ratio. App St also got their crowd game going last week (180, 4.7) and their OL has allowed just 9 sks on the season. App St does have the #130 pass D and ODU just threw for 304 yds last game. However, the last time App St was a home dog was in 2021 vs CCar (+4') and they pulled the outright upset 30-27 and we like App St to get revenge here and pull the outright home upset.

**UCF by 10 over Arizona** - Both teams come to this game on a losing streak as UCF has lost 5 straight (1-4 ATS) and while Ariz is on an 0-4 SU/ATS run after they were upset at home by West Virginia 31-26. UCF's offensive strength is their run game (239, 5.8 in B12 play) led by RJ Harvey (1017, 6.8) and Ariz has suffered some inj's on defense and allowed 203 rush yds (5.1) last week. UCF is allowing 446 ypg/35 ppg in B12 play (fired DC this week), but Ariz's offense is putting up just 364 ypg/19 ppg over the L/4 games and QB Fifta has just an 11-10 ratio. Ariz has yet to have an impressive game all season and have covered just 1 game all season and now travel to Florida in the heat/humidity. UCF's offense will have a great game here and if they are able to slow down WR McMillian the Knights will win by DD's here.

**ARMY by 20 over Air Force** - Since 2017 Army is 5-2 SU/6-1 ATS vs Air Force and the past 10 meetings have all gone 'Under' the Vegas total (avg 28 ppg). Army is a perfect 7-0 SU/6-0-1 ATS this season and are +178 ypg/+28 ppg and hold foes to 88 ypg under their season avg, but have played just the #130 schedule. Air Force is the complete opposite of Army, as the Falcons are just 1-6 SU and 0-7 ATS and they are -86 ypg/-12 ppg and are allowing foes to gain 13 ypg above their season average (#91 FBS) despite playing the #118 schedule. AF is allowing 241 rush ypg (5.8) the L/4 games and allowed 329 rush (6.9) to Navy a few weeks ago. Army is rushing for an FBS-best 359 ypg (6.6) led by QB Daily who is the team's #1 rusher (909, 6.6, 19 td) and Army allows just 80 rush ypg (3.3). While we think Army is the superior team, laying over 3 td's in a service academy game is tough and we think AF can stay within that line (first time spread is over 3 td's in this game s/03!).

**AUBURN by 3 over Vanderbilt** - Last year we cashed a 4★ LPS on Auburn when they held a 424-266 yd edge and beat Vandy 31-15 (-12'). Diego Pavia won't be intimidated by Jordan-Hare Stadium considering he led an upset with New Mexico St last year as 26 pt dogs, embarrassing Auburn on their home field. Auburn played their best game of the season last week, beating KY 24-10 with a 498-224 yd edge. Despite Auburn's 3-5 record, they are actually +106 ypg and +90 vs the SEC. Vandy was +17' hosting Texas last week and once again showed grit, only losing 27-24 and had a 402-392 yd edge though they did trail by DD's in the 3Q. Auburn's big issue has been turnovers. QB Payton Thorne has a 12-7 ratio and Auburn is -9 TO's while Vandy's QB Diego Pavia has a 13-3 ratio, is their #1 rusher with 537 (4.0) and the 'Dores are +6 TO's. Auburn's Jarquez Hunter leads the SEC with 863 rush (7.2) and just had 278 vs KY's D. Auburn is better than their record but Vandy does what they do and plays scrappy ball to keep it close.

**ARKANSAS by 1 over Ole Miss** - Ark is 10-1 ATS with 4 straight covers against Ole Miss and the home team has won 5 straight. The Hogs have also pulled 6 outright upsets in this series since '14. Ole Miss 6-2 with losses to KY and LSU and last week they trailed Oklahoma 14-10. Ark is 5-3 with wins over Auburn and Tennessee. They also led OKSt 21-0 and were up 17-14 in the 4Q vs A&M but lost both. Hogs are +133 ypg and off a dominant 58-25 win over Miss St where they put up 673 yards. QB Taylor Green threw for 314 yds and 5 td's. Ja'Quindent Jackson leads with 592 (5.7) and 10 td's. He sat out last week but Pittman says he should return this week. Ole Miss WR Tre Harris leads with 987 (16.7) but also missed last week. Pittman is 21-9-1 ATS as an underdog with 9 outright upsets and series history shows is on Arkansas' side. Hogs are getting over a touchdown and we think they pull yet another upset in front of a fired up home crowd.

**MARSHALL by 17 over Uim** - First meeting as FBS foes. Marshall has not played in over 2 weeks and are well-rested, while ULM is off their first SBC loss of the season, falling to SAIA 46-17 on the road (-136 yds). Marshall does come in with a strong rush attack (244 ypg, 6.2 ypc L/4 gms) led by RB AJ Turner (717, 10.1) and MU has made the switch to QB Braxton and he is hitting 59% with an 8-1 ratio and also has 275 rush (6.5). ULM's rush defense is letting up 222 ypg (5.4) in SBC play and just allowed SAIA to rush for 355 (7.4) last week! Despite playing just the #103 schedule, ULM's offense is putting up 81 ypg under what their foes typically allow (#127 FBS!) and MU is holding teams to 368 ypg at home. ULM is a tough team in SBC home games, but struggle on the road and we think MU runs all over them here & wins by over 2 td.

**MIAMI,FL by 24 over Duke** - Manny Diaz returns to face his old team whom he coached from '19-'21. Duke actually won the last meeting 45-21 as 9 pt dogs in '22. The home team is 1-5 SU/ATS and Duke has pulled the upset in 3 of the last 5. 'Canes had a season low 445 yards and Cam Ward finished with 0 passing td's but Miami covered as 21 pt home chalk last week vs FSU, winning 36-14. Diaz' teams were known for their Turnover Chain at Miami and he's done the same at Duke. The Blue Devils are #2 in the nation with 19 forced TO's. Duke was +6 TO's but still lost to SMU 28-27 in OT last week. Maalik Murphy threw for a ssn high 295 and 3 td's. Two weeks ago Duke was outgained by FSU 291-180 but was +4 TO's and won by 7. UM has only turned the ball over 7 times all year. Duke's pass D is #16 in our efficiency rankings (167 ypg, 57%, 7-9) but face by far their toughest test against the nation's #2 passer. The 'Canes won't turn the ball over and will wear out Duke's defense to win by over 3 td's.

**AKRON by 3 over Buffalo** - Buffalo has won the last 6 meetings (5-1 ATS) by 21.2 ppg but the last two have been by a combined 4 pts. Akron got their first FBS and MAC win in '24 last week, beating EMich 25-21 (+2). Zips led 18-0 at half but needed a late td drive led by QB Ben Finley to win the game. Akron ran for 220 (7.1) led by Jordan Simmons (16-109). Buffalo started 2-0 in MAC play with wins over NIU and Toledo but have now lost their last two to WMich and last week were crushed at Ohio 47-16 (+5). Bulls QB CJ Ogbonna does have an 8-2 ratio while Akron's Finley has an 8-8 ratio. Akron has been a little better than their record suggests. They only lost by 7 to Bowling Green and 10 at WMich where they had a 501-387 yd edge. Joe Moorhead is now 6-2 as a home dog and they've ply'd the tougher sked this year (#65 vs #105). We called for Akron to win last week and they did so we will go with the Zips to pull another upset.

**Toledo by 3 over EASTERN MICHIGAN** - Both teams enter here at 5-3 overall and 2-2 in MAC play. Toledo got back QB Gleason a week ago vs BG and he hit 30-45 for 320 but had a 2-2 ratio and UT lost to their cross-town rival. Despite EMich being +82 yds LW at Akron they trailed 18-0 HT but came back to lead 21-18 4Q before a late td by Akron gave EM the loss. Toledo is just +5 ypg in MAC play while EM is +31 ypg in MAC play. Neither team has played a tough schedule (UT #117, EM #129). EM has found their offense of late, putting up 432 ypg/31 ppg in MAC play and UT's yds allowed has gone up in every MAC game this season (all'd ssn high 402 to BG last week). Since 2017 EM is 42-16-1 ATS as an underdog and they are getting over a td at home and we think the Eagles keep this game close.

**BAYLOR by 7 over Tcu** - Since 2015 TCU is 8-1 SU/6-3 ATS against Baylor. After dropping their F3 Big 12 games, Baylor has won B2B conf games and have put up 500+ yds in both of those games. TCU has won 3 of their L/4 B12 games, but their L/2 wins have been by 6 pts or less. Baylor's offense has been led recently by their strong run game, putting up 255 (7.7) and 343 (9.0) the L/2 games and TCU is allowing 182 rush ypg (4.4) to B12 foes incl 289 (5.4) to UCF earlier this season. Baylor is also getting great QB play from Sawyer Robertson (60%, 17-4 ratio). TCU does have QB Hoover (66%, 19-8) and several skilled WR's that are taking on the Bears #57 pass D (59%, 13-7). Despite their lack of success in this series, we have been impressed with Baylor the past couple of weeks, and playing at home at night we think they get the win by a td.

**Northwestern by 7 over PURDUE** - The home team is just 4-8 SU/2-10 ATS since 2009. NW sits at just 3-5 on the season, but have played teams like Indiana and Wisconsin tough this season while Purdue has yet to beat an FBS team and 5 of their 6 losses are by 17+ points. NW QB Lausch has been solid since taking over as starter, and is a threat with his arm and legs. Purdue allows 215 rush ypg (5.2) and NW does have a solid RB in Cam Porter (369, 4.3). Purdue's defense overall allows foes to gain 117 ypg above their avg (#130 FBS!). NW allows just 351 ypg and Purdue is avg'g just 319 ypg/16 ppg in B10 play. NW has the big edge on defense (#48 vs #112), have the ST's edge as well (#54 vs #72) and also have the coaching edge with David Braun. With this line being under a fg, we think NW can win the game outright by a td.

**FLORIDA ST by 3 over North Carolina** - FSU has won the last two meetings in '20 & '21. NC lost four straight heading into last week then crushed Virginia 41-14 on the road. Heels led 24-6 at half w/a 275-77 yd edge. FSU is the first team since Maryland in 1956 to go undefeated in regular season then start the following season 1-7. 'Noles have yet to reach 300 yards in a game but NC

has a vulnerable defense that gives up 32 ypg more than their foes avg. FSU's defense held both Duke and Miami well below their ssn average and holds foes 55 ypg below their avg. 'Noles D has been particular good in the RZ, allowing 18 td's in 35 RZ attempts. FSU has ply'd our #2 toughest sked while NC has only ply'd our #67 toughest sked. The 'Noles haven't shown much give up and we will take the home team with the much stronger defense to win this game.

**Georgia by 10 over Florida** - The rivalry formerly known as the World's Largest Cocktail Party has been a lopsided affair in 9 of the last 10 years. UGA is 5-2 ATS vs Florida and won last year 43-20 (-14'). We called for Georgia's outright upset of Texas in these pages but the Dawgs are 0-5 ATS as a favorite since they beat Clemson 34-3 in the opener. Florida is 4-3 and has covered four straight. They nearly upset Tennessee on the road three weeks ago then put up a ssn high 48 points vs Kentucky in a 28 pt win prior to their bye. Frosh QB DJ Lagway threw for 259 yards on just 7 completions and true frosh RB Jadan Baugh had 106. Texas took advantage of a rusty Quinn Ewers but Lagway adds a different dimension and Gators are full of confidence. Napier's teams are 23-12-1 ATS as an underdog and we think they keep it closer than expected.

**NC STATE by 16 over Stanford** - Stanford is playing for the seventh straight week and makes their fourth to the ETZ, traveling roughly 2300 miles for an ACC game. NCST is fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they salvaged their season by rallying from down 13 4Q to beat Cal 24-23. CJ Bailey threw for 336 yards and now has an 8-4 ratio. The Wolfpack are 4-4 and have a great shot to win out with a soft slate in November. Stanford has lost five straight by 25 ppg and are -181 ypg in their L/4. Stanford went back to Ashton Daniels last week but he has a 6-8 ratio. We normally wouldn't be in favor of laying more than a td with NCST but this is where the travel finally wears Stanford out. This is clearly the Situation POW. Wolfpack get a confidence building win and Stanford hopefully rethinks this ACC thing.

**UTSA by 3 over Memphis** - UTSA won the only prior meeting 31-28 as 3 pt dogs. UTSA's loss to Tulsa last week surely will be mentioned on Bad Beats. They were -8 and led 35-7 at half with a 364-100 yd edge and 42-17 mid 3Q. Not only did UTSA not cover, but they lost outright, 46-45 despite putting up a ssn high 546 yards. Memphis trailed Charlotte 28-24 then scored a td with :31 seconds left and added a late safety. Two weeks ago Memphis allowed 445 pass yards to North Texas and now face UTSA's Owen McCown who threw for 434 and 4 td's last week. Memphis' Mario Anderson has 780 rush (5.7) and 13 td's but UTSA is allowing just 92 rush ypg (2.7). We think Traylor gets them to play inspired to make up for last week and we are giving UTSA another shot, calling for the upset.

**UTEP by 7 over Middle Tennessee** - Two first year HC's meet in the midst of rough seasons. MT has won the last 4 meetings though UTEP did cover last year as 8' pt road dogs, losing 34-30 and finished w/a 453-427 yd edge. MT is 2-6 and coming off a 42-20 loss at Jax St prior to their bye. UTEP is 1-7 and two weeks ago they lost 14-10 (+7) at LA Tech. Miners are -69 ypg in CUSA play while MT is -129. Blue Raiders are also -29 ppg and -226 ypg on the road with their closes loss coming at Memphis by 17 points. UTEP did beat FIU in their last home game 30-21 with a +85 yd edge. Neither team is going to a bowl, but we've seen a little more from UTEP lately and will call for the Miners to win by a td.

**IOWA ST by 17 over Texas Tech** - After going 0-5 SU/ATS vs TT from 2016-20, ISU has won & covered their L/2 meetings. ISU is off a bye week and are 7-0 SU/5-2 ATS on the season, while Tex Tech are off B2B losses after starting the season 5-1. TT is allowing 469 ypg/36 ppg in B12 play and they have the #82 pass D (63%, 18-10) and here they take on an ISU offense putting up 465 ypg in B12 play led by QB Becht (61%, 11-5). ISU is also running the ball well (223 ypg, 5.0 ypc in B12 play) and have 3 RB's over 300 rush yds and TT is allowing 156 rush ypg (5.0) the L/4 gms. TT did lose QB Morton last week (shoulder) and is ? here. If he is unable to go true frosh Will Hammond would be the guy. ISU does have a strong defense that is holding foes to 91 ypg under their ssn avg (#14 FBS) and after allowing a ssn-high in yds 2 weeks ago, ISU used their bye week to shore up their run defense and their pass D ranks #3 (51%, 5-12 ratio). ISU is laying around 2 td's but we like this matchup for them as TT is just 4-10 ATS on the road under HC McGuire.

**OKLAHOMA ST by 3 over Arizona St** - Okla St comes into this game having dropped all 5 Big 12 games this season and are in danger of missing out on a winning season & a bowl. Ariz St is off a bye week and sit at 5-2 on the season, but lost their last game at Cincy 24-14. Okla St does have talented offensive weapons such as RB Gordon & WR's Stripling and Presley, but QB Bowman is hitting just 60% with a 15-10 ratio and Gordon only has 546 yds (4.1). While we like Okla St here at home & needing a win, our biggest concern for the Cowboys is their run defense, as they are allowing 307 ypg (6.8) and ASU's top offensive weapon is RB Skattebo (848, 5.7, 10 td). ASU will likely get QB Leavitt back this week, but he is hitting just 59% with an 8-4 ratio. Needing a win to get back on track, we like the Cowboys here as a home dog as Okla St is 9-2 SU/ATS as a home underdog in Big 12 play since 2015!

**SMU by 11 over Pittsburgh** - First meeting since the 1983 Cotton Bowl which featured future HOF's Dan Marino and Eric Dickerson. This game has huge ACC Title game implications. SMU is 7-1, ranked #20 and 4-0 in ACC play. The Mustangs will be favored in their 3 remaining ACC games. Pitt is 7-0 and ranked #18 in the country though the Panthers do have a tough remaining ACC slate including a game against Clemson. This could be a battle of backup QB's with both SMU's Jennings and Pitt's Holstein questionable. This situation would favor SMU who has last year's starting QB Preston Stone on the bench. Stone has a 32-7 ratio the last two years while Pitt's Nate Yarnell has 3 career starts and a 7-1 ratio over 3 years. Pitt's offense has sputtered in their last two games with just 277 yds vs Cal and 217 yards vs Cuse though Pitt did run just 44 plays last week thanks to 3 Pick-6's. SMU was -6 TO's last week but pulled out a 1 pt win over Duke. Mustangs should have a fired up home crowd after not playing a single home game in October. We want to see what happens with the QB's and will call for SMU to win by DD's for now.

**ILLINOIS over Minnesota** - ILL has won and covered the L/3 meetings, pulling the outright upset in all 3 games. ILL was off their biggest game of the season 2 wks ago & predictably were in a flat spot LW vs Oregon & lost 38-9. MIN has won 3 games in a row after winning 48-23 LW vs Maryland. MIN is only avg'g 325 ypg in B10 play and have been held to under 300 yds in 3 of their 5 B10 games. ILL is +54 ypg at home and are 5-0 SU at home this season. ILL QB Altmyer is hitting 63% with a 15-3 ratio and MIN just allowed a ssn-high 323 pass yds LW. ILL also has a big ST's edge here (#42 vs #99) and are +10 TO's at home this ssn. This is MIN's 3rd road gm and lost at Mich and barely got by UCLA 21-17 (outgained 329-234). ILL is 15-6 ATS as a B10 dog since 2021 incl going 3-1 this season with upsets over Nebraska & Mich. We think this is a great spot for ILL getting pts at home and like them to pull the outright upset!

**Navy by 20 over RICE** - Navy won the last 4 meetings but they haven't met since '09. We easily cashed a 3★ Key Selection on these pages and a 4★ LPS last week going against Navy in their 51-14 (+14) loss to Notre Dame. Rice has put up just 20 points in their last two games, losses to Tulsa and UConn which led to HC Mike Bloomgren getting fired on Monday. True freshman Drew Devillier got his first career start and threw for just 88 yards. Rice did take the option once this year already in a 37-14 loss to Army though they did hold the Black Knights to a ssn low of 408 total yards and 288 (5.1) rush. ST's Coor Pete Alamar will serve as the Interim. Normally we think a team who fires their coach will play inspired the next week but it's not ideal to face a tricky offense like Navy's triple option during turmoil and prior to the loss LW, Navy had won their previous six games by 25 ppg yet are laying just 11 points here.

**UAB by 6 over TULSA** - UAB is 0-4 SU but 3-1 ATS in this series but they haven't met since 2012 and this is their first meeting as AAC foes. Tulsa is now 3-5 SU/ATS after last week's miraculous win over UTSA. The Hurricane trailed 35-7 at half and 42-17 mid 3Q then rallied to pull out a 46-45 win, busting our 3★ LPS on UTSA in the process. UAB is fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they had a 485-355 yd edge but settled for four fg's and lost 35-25 to USF. Now UAB is 3 pt favorites in Protective Stadium where they've gone 34-8 SU since '16. UAB is also 7-2 as a home favorite since '21 while Tulsa is 17-5-1 ATS as a road dog since '19. Neither team inspires us but we do give UAB a slight edge in all 3 phases and they are tough at home.

**Kansas St by 12 over HOUSTON** - KSt comes into this game in the thick of the B12 race & are 7-1 on the season, while HOU has won 2 of the L/3 B12 games. KSt does hold foes to 39 ypg under their season avg and are allowing just 342 ypg on the season. HOU's offense did get QB Chris back last week, but overall on the season are only avg'g 292 ypg and 12 ppg in conf play. On the other hand HOU has been getting good play from its defense, as they are holding teams to 85 ypg under their season avg (#18 FBS). However KSt does move the ball well (435 ypg) and they are avg'g 215 rush ypg (5.7) in B12 play led by RB Diggins (945, 6.5) and HOU has all'd 240 rush (6.3) vs ISU and 220 rush (6.7) to Kan so they can get gashed. However, KSt is just 1-6 ATS the L/2 ssn's as an away favorite and we'll call for HOU to stay within the spread.

**Coastal Carolina by 9 over TROY** - As SBC foes these teams have split the 6 meetings, but Troy has covered 5 of the 6 games. All 6 meetings have gone 'Over' the total with an avg of 68 pts scored in each game. Coastal does enter this game off a bye, but have dropped 3 of their L/4 games incl their L/2 SBC games at JMU and vs LA. However, Troy is not at that level, as they have yet to beat an FBS foe this season. However last week at Ark St trailed 23-3 HT but came back to lead 31-26 4Q before allowing the GW td with :33 sec left. Troy has now turned to QB Caldwell, who threw for 304 yds LW but also had 3 int's. Troy's defense did allow 534 yds LW and 467 to TXSt a few wks ago, and here face a Coastal team that put up 400 yds vs LA. Coastal QB Vasko hitting just 52% with an 8-4 ratio, but should have success vs a Troy pass D ranked #121 (69%, 7-3). Coastal is laying under a TD and we feel they are at least a td better than Troy here.

**SOUTH ALABAMA by 3 over Georgia Southern** - From 2014-20 GSthrn was 7-0 SU/6-1 ATS vs SAAla, but the L/2 meetings the Jags have won & covered. SAAla enters this game having won 4 of their L/6 gms and are off home wins vs Troy (25-9) and ULM (46-17). GSthrn had won 3 in a row prior to last Thurs game at ODU where they trailed 30-7 HT and lost 47-19 where they allowed 560 yds. SAAla is rushing for 249 ypg in SBC play and last week had 355 (7.4) where both Bullock and Bothwell both topped 100 yds. GS's run D has been hot and cold, allowing 256 (6.2) to ODU and 200 (4.7) to Marshall, but just 29 (1.9) and 67 (2.1) to JMU. SAAla does have the #69 pass D (63%, 11-11) allowing 256 pass ypg and they did allow ULM to rush for 238 (6.4) a week ago. GSthrn QB Frech is hitting 64% (12-6). Two weeks ago GSthrn played JMU and pulled the outright upset, and we expect to see that team in this game and think they give SAAla a close game.

**WASHINGTON by 4 over Usc** - Met just last season as P12 foes where UW won 52-42 in a game that featured almost 1,100 total yards. However these teams look vastly different than they did in that meeting. UW is just 4-4 on the season and have dropped 3 of their L/4 games. USC last week snapped a 3 game losing streak, beating Rutgers 42-20. UW does have a strong defense that is holding foes to 116 ypg under their avg (#5 FBS!) and held Indiana to their season-low in yards (312 yds). Washington also has the #5 pass D (49%, 6-5) and are allowing just 123 pass ypg, but have only played the #95 schedule and this is the best pass attack they have faced. USC does have the edge on offense (#15 vs #48) and ST's (#26 vs #132) but UW has the edge on defense (#25 vs #60) as USC has allowed 460 ypg the L/3 gms incl 362 pass ypg and here face UW QB Rogers (72%, 13-4). UW will also have the home crowd on their side and we like the Hokies to get the outright win as home underdogs as USC is just 2-8 ATS under HC Riley as a conf away favorite & have have lost all 3 conf road games as chalk this season.

**IOWA by 7 over Wisconsin** - Iowa has won and covered 3 of the L/4 meetings. In the L/4 mtgs the 'Under' has hit with an avg of just 31 ppg. Iowa sits at 5-3 and are off a 40-14 win vs NW where they were +192 yds and +2 TO's. Iowa made the switch to QB Sullivan last week, who adds a running element and hit 9-14 passes. Iowa's bread & butter on offense is RB Kaleb Johnson, who has 1,144 yds (7.8, 16 td) on the season. Overall Iowa avg's 209 rush ypg (5.9) and Wisc did just allow 173 (4.9) to Penn St and also allowed 168 (4.8) to Rutgers. Iowa is allowing 64% passing but they have 10 int's on the season and Wisc QB Locke only has a 7-6 ratio. On defense Iowa does hold teams to 51 ypg under their ssn avg and allow just 104 rush ypg (3.5). The line is sitting at around a fg and Iowa is 17-1 SU in their L/18 Nov games and are 4-0 at home this season where they are +116 ypg/+21 ppg. We like the Hawkeyes here by a td.

**Oregon by 17 over MICHIGAN** - The Ducks come into this meeting 8-0 and #1 in the country while Mich has 3 losses on the season, but did just beat rival Mich St, despite getting outgained 352-265 yds. Mich's struggles this season have been on offense, as they are only putting up 287 ypg in B10 play, while the Ducks defense is holding foes to 95 ypg under their season avg (#12 FBS!) despite playing the #28 schedule. Mich still has a strong defense, holding foes to 73 ypg under their season avg, but did allow 389 yds to Texas when they hosted them earlier this ssn & Oregon's offense is just as potent, as they are putting up 120 ypg more than their foes allow (#6 FBS!). Mich does only have the #52 pass D (64%, 14-6) and could be without CB Johnson (inj). Oregon QB Gabriel is hitting 76% (18-5 ratio) and the Ducks have an ultra-talented WR room. The Ducks also protect the QB well, allowing just 10 sks on 261 pass att. UO is 7-3 ATS s/'22 as a conf AF and we like the Ducks to win by over 2 td's as Mich will not be able to keep up offensively.

**NEW MEXICO by 7 over Wyoming** - NMex is a favorite vs WY for the first time since 2017! The Lobos have covered 4 of the L/5 meetings (all as dog) even pulling the outright upset in both '20 and '21. NMex is in a rare role of being a MW favorite, as this is just the 3rd time in this role since '21! However they were in this role just 2 wks ago at USU and did get the win 50-45. WY has struggled this season and are 1-7 and their bowl hopes are dashed. The Lobos offense is putting up 481 ypg/32 ppg vs MW foes this season led by QB Dampier who has 2,079 pass yds & is also their #1 rusher (524, 6.4). WY's defense is allowing foes to gain 31 ypg above their season avg (#102 FBS) and are allowing 169 rush ypg (4.8). The Lobos weakness this season has been defense, allowing foes to gain 107 ypg above their season avg (#128 FBS) but did allow a season-low 334 yds last week at Colo St. However, the Lobos defense still can't be trusted and WY has put up 391 ypg the L/4 gms and we'll call for this to finish right around the line.

**MISSISSIPPI ST by 23 over UMass** - Miss St won the last two meetings by just 11 and 12 points. Bulldogs are still looking for their first FBS win under Jeff Leiby. They've lost 7 straight. QB Michael Van Buren has taken on Texas, Georgia, A&M and Ark in his four starts and has an 8-4 ratio. UMass is 2-6 but both wins were over FCS foes. Against FBS foes they are -19.8 ppg and -49 ypg. The Minutemen are 9-2 ATS vs the SEC but earlier this year they lost 45-3 at Missouri. Miss St allows 478 ypg and 94 ypg more than their foes avg. Their pass D is the worst among P4 teams, allowing 73% and an 18-6 ratio but they've also faced our #10 sked while UMass has only faced our #127 sked. Leiby will want to get his young QB some confidence so we do expect Miss St to put up a lot of points and win a high scoring game by over 3 td's.

**TENNESSEE by 24 over Kentucky** - Vols have owned this series, going 28-10 ATS since 1987. They've won 10 of the last 12 meetings and are on a 14-3 ATS run. LTH Vols were -11' and crushed KY 44-6. KY avg just 14 ppg and 276 ypg in SEC play. Vols are fresh off a bye. They have gone 3 straight games w/o scoring a single point in the 1st half yet beat both Florida and Bama. KY's D was all the rave after their first 5 games but they've allowed 476 and 498 in their last 2. KY allowed Auburn's Jarquez Hunter to rush for 278 last week and now they face the SEC's #2 rusher in Dylan Sampson (840, 5.8, 17 td's). Vols D allows just 259 ypg and is holding foes 122 ypg below their avg. 'Cats QB Brock Vandagriff only has a 3-4 ratio and backup Gavin Wimsatt replaced him last week then went 3 of 10 for 34 yds and an int. Look for the Vols strong run game to open up deep shots for lamaleava. If the Vols get a lead this could get ugly fast and Heupel is 14-6 as a home favorite!

**FRESNO ST by 13 over Hawaii** - Fresno has gone 9-3 SU/7-4-1 ATS vs UH s/'11. Fresno sits at 3-1 in MW play and still in the hunt for a berth in the MW title game, while UH did just pick up their first win vs an FBS foe last week, beating Nevada 34-13. On the road Hawaii is -75 ypg/-18 ppg and face a Fresno team that just beat San Jose St at home 33-10 where they put up 401 yds and were +3 TO's. Fresno QB Keene did hit 73% last week with a 3-1 ratio and Hawaii does have the #110 pass D (66%, 12-4). Fresno is allowing just 325 ypg the L/3 gms and they have 10 sacks, while UH is putting up just 333 ypg the L/4 gms. Fresno has the better defense (#54 vs #75) and has taken on the tougher schedule (#92 vs #121). Fresno has been disappointing at times TY, but this UH team tends to struggle on the road, so we will put this game right around the line.

**PENN ST by 3 over Ohio St** - Penn St has beaten OSU just 1 time since 2012 (24-21 at home in 2016) but since 2014 are 7-3 ATS in the series (all as a dog). Penn St is 7-0 SU, but just 3-4 ATS. However this is the first time they are an underdog this season. OSU is just 0-3-1 ATS as a road favorite vs a top 10 team since 2021 and one of those losses was this ssn at Oregon where they allowed 496 yds and made crucial errors down the stretch. PSU does have some inj concerns as QB Allar is ? here (likely GTD) as is DE Dennis-Sutton and OT Donkah who were all inj'd vs Wisc last week. OSU was shut down LW vs Nebraska (285 yds) and now face a PSU D holding foes to 106 ypg under their avg (#7 FBS!). PSU also has the #17 pass D (57%, 6-6) and they shut down the run (93, 3.2). This is PSU's best shot to beat OSU in awhile and we like the Nitnity Lions, in front of their fired up crowd to get the upset win!
