4★ INDIANA over Michigan - Since 1988 Indiana has beaten Mich just 1 time SU and that was back in 2020 at home 38-21. This is also the first time Indiana is a favorite against Mich since at least 1976. Indy's perfect season rolls on as they spotted Mich St 10 pts last week and still won 47-10 (-7) as the Hoosiers picked up a 4★ Power Sweep Winner & a 4★ LP play for us! Indy got back QB Rourke last week and threw for 263 yds (66%) with a 4-0 ratio. Indy is also getting strong play from their defense, as they are holding foes to 84 ypg under their ssn avg (#17) and overall are allowing 298 ypg in B10 play. Indy also has 31 sks on the ssn and their OL has all'd just 7 sks. Mich's offense only avg's 285 ypg in B10 play and last week allowed 470 yds to Oregon. Mich avg's just 12 ypg on the road this season & Indy is +156 ypg at home vs FBS foes. Indy is winning B10 games by 27 ppg and are 9-0 SU/ATS this season and we see no reason to not back them again here and make them the top Power Sweep play once again!

FORECAST: INDIANA by 24

3★ South Carolina over VANDERBILT - SC is 15-0 SU vs Vandy including 7 straight wins in Nashville. The Gamecocks are on an 8-1 ATS series run and last year were -13' and won 47-6. Vandy is the surprise of the SEC at 6-3 and ranked in the AP Poll for the first time since '13. Last week the 'Dores were held to a ssn low 227 yards yet upset Auburn 17-7 on the road. We called for SC to pull the upset last week vs A&M and SC won in both the stats and the scoreboard, 44-20 w/a 530-350 yd edge. LaNorris Sellers threw for a ssn high 244 yards and rushed for 106 while Rocket Sanders looked like his old self with 144 yards. Vandy is -44 ypg vs the SEC while SC is +24. We've been impressed with Vandy's resiliency this year but SC is only laying a fg and we love their deep Dline (31 sks) to cause Diego Pavia some problems. We cashed a 3★ Key Selection on these pages last week on SC in their upset over A&M and with Vandy just getting bowl eligible we think they are in for a letdown while SC still needs a win to get bowl eligible themselves. Go Cocks!

FORECAST: South Carolina by 14

3★ NC STATE over Duke - Duke is 3-1 SU/ATS in the series but NCSt did win LTH 31-20 (-4). The Wolfpack are now 5-4 and last week were in a beautiful situation, fresh off a bye and playing Stanford who was making their 4th trip to the ETZ in 6 weeks. We easily cashed our 4★ Top Totals play on the Over 47 with NCSt putting up ssn highs of 59 points, 527 yards and 281 rush yards in a 59-28 win. CJ Bailey now has an 11-4 ratio and NCSt is avg 306 pass ypg in their L/4. Duke started 5-0 but have lost 3 of their L/4. They did nearly upset SMU two weeks ago and last week were up 28-17 vs Miami but lost 53-31 (+20'). NCSt is +20 ypg in ACC play while Duke is -91. In Duke's two ACC wins they trailed North Carolina 20-0 and were outgained 291-180 by Florida St. We think the Buy sign is flashing on NCSt right now and they are only laying 3 points here which is extremely cheap at home. We are calling for the Wolfpack to win by double-digits for a Key Selection and will also have the Over in the mix after last week's easy winner!

FORECAST: NC STATE by 14

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Iowa St over KANSAS - ISU has lost 2 straight one-score games to KU after winning the previous 7 meetings, so the Cyclones are out for revenge. ISU did suffer their first loss last week at home vs Tex Tech 23-22, but still have a shot at the B12 title and are no longer playing with unbeaten pressure. KU is off their 2nd bye week, and 2 weeks ago led rival KSt on the road 27-23 into the 4Q before allowing KSt to come back & win. KU is allowing 450 ypg in B12 play and ISU does average 458 ypg/30 ppg in conf play. ISU is also rushing for 205 (4.8) in B12 play led by RB's Hansen (444, 5.5) and Sama (377, 5.2) and KU is allowing 187 (5.1) rush in B12 play, incl allowing 226 (5.9) to KSt in their last game. Off a loss ISU is 13-6-1 ATS since 2020 and will be re-focused. Even though this is technically a home game for KU, the Cyclones could have the crowd edge here. Out for revenge we like the Cyclones to win here by almost 2 td's.

FORECAST: Iowa St by 13

2★ Georgia over OLE MISS - UGA is 11-1 SU/8-4 ATS in this series. The Bulldogs were -10' last year at home and won 52-17. Ole Miss is 7-2 and must win to stay in the mix for a playoff spot. Last week Ole Miss was -7' at Arkansas. QB Jaxson Dart threw for 515 yards and 6 td's and the Rebels romped to a 63-31 win. Georgia is a bad first half against Bama away from being 8-0. The Bulldogs won at Texas 30-15 and held the Longhorns to just 38 1st half yards. Ole Miss leads the nation in sacks with 41 but Georgia has allowed just 10 all season. UGA has played the tougher schedule with wins over Texas and Clemson (#8 toughest sked) while Ole Miss has losses to KY and LSU and trailed Oklahoma at half (#65 toughest sked). Georgia also has the ST's edge (#2 vs #36). We like Georgia's physicality to be the difference in this game and they are only laying 2' points.

FORECAST: Georgia by 10

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 6th

Ohio by 27 over KENT ST - Since 2014 Ohio is 7-2 SU/6-3 ATS against Kent St and last season won & covered with a 42-17 win where Ohio was +238 yds! Ohio and Kent St both played last the final Sat of Oct so both teams are well-rested. Ohio is still in the hunt for the MAC title game (3-1 in MAC play) but could still be without RB Tyus (610, 5.4) who missed last game & HC Albin said he'd miss multiple weeks. However they still have RB Hunt (268, 4.9) and QB Navarro is a good runner (508, 6.2). Kent St's run D is awful, allowing 266 ypg (6.0) and in their last game allowed 358 rush (9.7) to WMich. Kent's defense overall is allowing foes to gain 174 ypg over their season avg (LAST in the FBS). Kent's offense also struggles, as they are putting up 135 ypg under what their foes allow (#133 FBS) as they average just 251 ypg and their passing attack is hitting just 46%. Ohio's defense is allowing just 295 ypg in MAC play and are +116 ypg in conf play while Kent is -145 ypg. Even with the line approaching 3 td's, we love Ohio in this situation.

Northern Illinois by 6 over WESTERN MICHIGAN - NIU has won the last two meetings. Last year NIU was off two straight close losses. They were -5' and won 24-0 with a 386-206 yd edge. The Huskies once again come in off two straight losses and are only laying 1'. NIU is 4-4 and all four losses have come by 7 points or less. They also have quality wins at Notre Dame and Bowling Green. NIU's defense allows just 276 ypg and holds foes 101 ypg below their average. WMich has won 4 straight but those all came against the bottom of the MAC (Ball St, Akron, Buff & Kent St). Despite the weaker MAC schedule, WMich is +54 ypg in MAC play while NIU is +83 in MAC play. WMich's D is allowing 431 ypg and they are allowing 119 ypg more than their foes average. Their pass D is #122, allowing 258 ypg (63%, 14-6). NIU clearly has the better defense and the better wins and they just need to win the game. We think Hammock's squad will get the job done.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 7th

EAST CAROLINA by 7 over FAU - EC has won the last 2 meetings including last year 22-7 as 7' point road dogs and Pirates held FAU to just 172 yds. Prior to their bye EC played their first game under Interim HC Blake Harrell. EC trailed Temple 21-20 2Q. They put up a ssn high 56 points and won by 22, rushing for 231 (6.4). FAU has lost 3 straight. The Owls must win out to be bowl eligible. Last week they led USF 21-14 3Q but lost 44-21 (+2'). EC is -67 ypg vs AAC foes while

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FAU is -125. EC's QB Katin Houser has a 7-3 ratio in the last two games after taking over for turnover prone Jake Garcia. EC does have a huge edge in ST's (#10 vs #116) which could make the difference. Both teams are inconsistent so we are putting this at the line.

Appalachian St by 7 over COASTAL CAROLINA - There have been 3 straight outright upsets in this series with Coastal winning the L/2 meetings. The last 3 meetings have been decided by 7 pts or less. App St has won 2 in a row and just pulled the home upset of ODU last week, while Coastal has now lost 3 straight as they fell at Troy 38-24 where they allowed 511 yds incl 342 rush (6.2). Over the last 4 games App St is +32 ypg while Coastal is -125 ypg. Over the L/4 games Coastal's defense is allowing 478 ypg and App's offense is putting up 435 ypg the L/4 gms. Coastal has the #110 pass D and App St QB Aguilar has a 7-1 ratio in their L/2 games. Coastal is 2-7 ATS as a HF in SBC play, however this line is under a fg and could flip to App being the favorite by game day. We think App St is the better team, are trending upward & will back them here.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 8th

California by 6 over WAKE FOREST - This is Cal's final trip to the Eastern Time Zone this year. First meeting. Cal did travel to the state of North Carolina in '17 and beat the Tar Heels 35-30 (+12'). WF is fresh off a bye and barely escaped against Cal's rival two weeks ago, beating Stanford 27-24 on the road. Cal is 4-4 but all four losses have come by 5 points or less and two weeks ago they crushed Oregon St 44-7 (-10') with a 478-200 yd edge. The Bears also led NCSt by 13 4Q and led Miami 38-13 3Q, both 1 point losses. Cal has a big edge on D, holding foes 75 ypg below their avg while WF is allowing teams to put up 32 ypg more than their avg. Against FBS teams WF is 3-0 on the road but 0-4 SU/ATS at home and the Deacons are on an 0-7 ATS run at Truist Field dating back to last year. Cal isn't usually a team we want to back on the road and WF likes to keep games close so we have the slightest lean on the Deacons.

MEMPHIS by 8 over Rice - Last met in 2012, won by Memphis 14-10 (-5). Tigers are 5-0 SU/2-3 ATS and +80 ypg at home this year. Rice is 0-4 SU/1-2-1 ATS and -106 ypg on the road. Memphis is 7-2 but just took their 2nd AAC loss, falling 44-36 at UTSA despite a 516-408 yd edge. QB Seth Henigan threw for 454 and now has a 16-5 ratio. Rice played their first game under Interim HC Pete Alamar last week. The Owls held Navy to a ssn low 260 yards and won 24-10. EJ Warner returned from injury and threw for 239 yds while RB Dean Connors ran for 105. Rice actually has the edge on D and they have played a slightly tougher sked. Rice did only lose by 2 td's at Tulane a few weeks ago and we think they can keep it to single-digits here.

Iowa by 10 over UCLA - Iowa heads out West to play in the Rose Bowl and they are off an impressive 42-10 win over Wisconsin last Sat where we picked up a 3★ late phone play. Iowa ran for an impressive 329 yds (6.1) led by stud RB Johnson (1279, 7.5, 19 td) who ran for 135 (5.6) last week. UCLA can defend the run well (108, 3.5 in B10 play) but this could be the best rushing attack UCLA has faced all season. The Bruins have the #89 pass D allowing 261 ypg (66%, 15-6 ratio) and Iowa is now going with Sullivan at QB, and he is a true dual-threat player. Where UCLA struggles is on offense, as they are only putting up 306 ypg/19 ppg in B10 play and face Iowa defense that is holding foes to 61 ypg under their season avg (#27). Iowa also holds edges on ST's (#30 vs #87) and they have a big coaching edge with the veteran Ferentz on the sideline vs the rookie head coach Foster for UCLA. We like the Hawkeyes to go on the road & get the win by DD's!

SAN DIEGO ST by 10 over New Mexico - SDSt has won 9 straight meetings and more recently have covered 4 of the L/5 meetings. Last met in '22 and SDSt (-14') won 34-10 (+240 yds). SDSt comes in avg'g just 312 ypg on offense, but should have more success against a NMex defense allowing foes to gain 140 ypg above their season avg (#133 FBS!) and last week allowed 604 yards to Wyoming last week. NMex does allow 237 rush ypg (5.8) and SDSt RB Cooper has 842 rush (4.6) and should have a big day here. NMex does have a strong offense, avg'g 500 ypg in MW play led by QB Dampier (2243 pass, 731 rush). SDSt did allow 541 yds last week but in their previous 3 games allowed under 375 yds. We think the Aztecs offense will have a big day and their defense will get enough stops to win by two scores.

SATURDAY November 2nd

PITTSBURGH by 13 over Virginia - Pitt has won six of the last 7 meetings (4-3 ATS) but the home team is 1-3 SU/0-4 ATS. HC Narduzzi has shown confidence in QB Eli Holstein who has a 17-6 ratio but the Panthers have struggled offensively in their last 3 games. They were 7-0 going to SMU last week but fell behind 31-3 and were outgained 299-143 in the 1H of a 23 point loss. UVA started the ssn 4-1 but has lost 3 straight. The Cavaliers are fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they were -3 against NCar. UVA was outgained 428-288 and lost 41-14. QB Anthony Colandrea threw 2 int's in that game and now faces a Pitt D that had 5 int's vs Syracuse two weeks ago. Pitt had the edges on defense (#50 vs #71) and ST's (#18 vs #69). Narduzzi is 18-24-3 as a HF but 3-1 this year. Elliott is 8-3 as a road dog. We think Holstein will get back on track this week and lead Pitt to a win by nearly 2 td's.

TEXAS by 24 over Florida - Two powerhouse programs meet for the first time since 1940. Florida was giving Georgia all they could handle last week until QB DJ Lagway's injury. The Gators led 13-6 2Q when Lagway was hurt. They turned to Yale W/O QB Aidan Warner who finished 7 of 22 for 66 yards and 1 int and the Gators lost 34-20. Lagway hasn't yet been ruled out but whoever plays at QB will have to face one of the nation's top defenses. Texas is allowing just 241 ypg and they are holding foes 139 ypg below their avg (#2 in FBS) led by LB Anthony Hill (58 tkl, 5.5 sk, 4.5 tfl, 1 int). No team has reached 300 yards against Texas this season and the Longhorns are fresh off a bye. Napier is 24-12-1 ATS as a dog in his career and the Gators have covered all 3 games away from home this year but it's tough to see them keeping this close if they are starting a Walk-On QB so we have Texas by over 3 td's.

CINCINNATI by 1 over West Virginia - WVU enters this game off a bye week and had an extra week to rest up as they are dealing with several inj's to key players. QB Greene is still ? here as is RB Donaldson. Cincy also enters in here off a bye and are 4-1-1 ATS over their last 6 games. However, WVU got good QB play from Nicco Marichol, who was 18-22 for 198 yds & 2 td's and RB White ran for 92 yds in their last game vs Ariz. WVU's offense is at its best when they can run the ball (247 rush ypg, 5.4 in 3 FBS wins, 143 rush ypg, 3.6 in 4 FBS losses) and Cincy can give up some rush yds (176, 4.7 in B12 play). WVU does also hold foes to 36 ypg under their season avg and Cincy has put up just 362 ypg over their L/3 games. Cincy is laying over a fg in this one, but we like WVU to keep it close and potentially even pull the outright upset.

Miami, FI by 6 over GEORGIA TECH - UM likely had this game circled all offseason after losing this game last year in a remarkable way. Mario Cristobal elected to not kneel the ball to run the clock out, they fumbled and GT scored the game winning 44 yd td pass with 1 second left. The 'Canes had a 453-250 yd edge but were -3 TO's. The 'Canes are 9-0 but have been playing with fire, trailing by two scores in 3 of their last 5 games and were tied 4Q with Louisville. Last week Miami trailed Duke 28-17 3Q and led 32-31 4Q then had td drives of 51, 68 and 30 yards for a misleading win, 52-31 (-20'). GT is 5-4 and have lost their last two to Notre Dame by 18 and at VTech 21-6 but did have a 356-233 yd edge and were missing QB Haynes King in both. Brent Key is 5-1 SU/ATS vs ranked ACC teams and King could return this week. Miami has 27 sacks but GT has one of the best Olines in the country, allowing just 4 sacks all season. If Miami does have a late lead there is no doubt they kneel the ball this time and we like the Jackets to keep this close.

Navy by 3 over USF - Last year USF held Navy to 330 yards and pulled the upset 44-30 (+4). The Bulls are 4-4 with losses to Bama, Miami, FL, Tulane and Memphis. Last week they were clearly angry about last year's game vs FAU when HC Herman tried a late onside kick late in 4Q of a 56-14 blowout. USF actually trailed 14-7 and was outgained 306-195 in the 1H and still trailed 21-14 3Q then scored the game's final 30 pts, for a misleading 23 point win. Navy started 6-0 against a soft early slate but they've lost two straight. They were -6 TO's against Notre Dame in a 51-14 loss then last week held to a ssn low 260 yds by Rice in a 24-10 loss. USF has ply'd the tougher sked (#65 vs #116). Navy is out for revenge and USF is coming off an in-state rival so we like the Middies to win but not by more than a fg.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 5 over Syracuse - BC comes in fresh off a bye and have lost three straight but did cover two weeks ago against Louisville as 7' pt dogs when they led 20-0 2Q but fell apart and lost by 4. Cuse is now 6-2 after beating VTech but the Hokies were w/o QB Drones and RB Tuten. The Orange trailed 21-3 2Q and had to go 75/14 plays for a td with :29 left to tie then won in OT. Cuse QB McCord has a 21-12 ratio while BC is #34 in our pass D rankings, allowing 225 pass ypg and an 8-11 ratio. BC QB Castellanos has a 17-4 ratio and Syracuse is #116 in our pass D rankings, allowing 67% with a 12-6 ratio. BC is -62 ypg vs ACC foes while Cuse is +46 but BC has ply'd the tougher sked. BC needs this game badly for their bowl hopes and we think they get it by under a td.

JAMES MADISON by 21 over Georgia St - Only prior meeting was last season and JMU (-6) went on the road and won 42-14 with a 567-228 yd edge! JMU enters here off a bye and sit at 6-2 on the season (2 SBC losses), but do still have a shot at getting to the SBC title game. GST has dropped 5 straight since their upset win vs Vandy, and are allowing 419 ypg/32 ppg over those L/5 games. JMU's offense has struggled a bit lately, putting up just 358 ypg after putting up 459 ypg in their F/4 games. JMU is allowing SBC foes to gain just 291 ypg and only 18 ppg and in home games are allowing just 102 rush ypg (2.9). This is GST's 4th road game in a row with no bye week to break up the travel while JMU has been prepping for this game for 2 weeks. The spread is over 2 td's, but we think JMU is the much stronger team & have the big situational edge.

OHIO ST by 42 over Purdue - Since 1999 Ohio St is 7-0 SU/4-2-1 ATS at home vs Purdue. Ohio St is off a big road win vs Penn St where they held PSU to 270 yds and 6 pts as the Nittany Lions lone TD was on a pick-six. Purdue has lost 7 straight games and 5 of those losses are 17+ points. Purdue is allowing foes to gain 124 ypg above their season avg (#130 FBS) and Ohio St puts up 127 ypg above what their foes allow (#4 FBS) and QB Howard is hitting 73% with a 19-5 ratio and he faces a Purdue pass D ranked #127 (65%, 12-4 ratio). Meanwhile OSU's pass D ranks #41 and as allowed just a 4-6 ratio and they are #1 in the country holding foes to 145 ypg under their avg! OSU has Northwestern on deck, so there is no look-ahead spot here and even with the line being over 5 td's, we like the Buckeyes to steamroll Purdue by 6 td's.

Liberty by 14 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - Liberty looks to bounce back from two straight losses. The Flames won the two previous meetings over MT including last year 42-35 (-14'). Last week Liberty was -2 against Jax St. They were down 24-21 and drove to the JaxSt17 but were SOD then QB Salter threw a pick-6. MT is 3-6 but did win at UTEP last week. The Blue Raiders -111 ypg but only -31 at home. Liberty is +96 ypg but +131 in their two road games but did lose at Kennesaw St. Salter has started to use his legs more. MT's six losses are all by at least 17 points and Liberty is only laying 10' points. Liberty is 9-1 ATS when laying less than 2 td's under Chadwell so we have a decent lean on the Flames in a bounce back game.

Byu by 4 over UTAH - 102 meeting of the Holy War rivalry! Last met in 2021 where BYU (+7) snapped a 9 game series losing streak and upset the Utes 26-17 at home. BYU enters this game 8-0 and the lone unbeaten team left in the B12. Their offense the last 2 games has put up 473 and 480 yds and the run game has gotten going, rushing for 255 (7.1) and 252 (4.9). BYU's OL has also allowed just 9 sacks. Utah has dropped 4 straight and are without QB Rising for the rest of the season. Backup QB Isaac Wilson (brother played at BYU!) is hitting just 55% with an 8-8 ratio and 3rd string QB Brandon Rose got into the last game & was 7-15 passing. Utah is holding foes to 82 ypg under their season avg (#20) and in B12 play are allowing just 316 ypg/19 ppg. However their offense is putting up 44 ypg under what their foes allow (#109). BYU does hold teams to 70 ypg under their avg (#23) and their pass D ranks #1 (52%, 8-14 ratio). Utah is at home and are desperate for a win, but BYU just keeps finding ways to win & they will here.

BOISE ST by 31 over Nevada - Since 2011 Boise is 7-1 SU against Nevada and more recently have covered 3 of the last 5 games. Last met in '22 when Boise (-20') went to Nevada and won 41-3 (528-250 yds edge). Boise looks like the top G5 team in the country as they are 7-1 with their only loss coming by 3 pts at Oregon. Boise is trying to get RB Jeanty (1525, 8.0, 20 td) the Heisman as he has over 30 carries the L/3 games. Boise QB Madsen had his best game of the season last Fri, going 24-32 for 307 with a 4-0 ratio. Nev has been a scrappy team and in MW play are +13 ypg. Nev's run D has allowed 188 (4.7) the L/4 games and now face their toughest test yet. Nev also has just the #64 pass D. Boise is holding foes to 34 ypg under their season avg and at home are +188 ypg/+32 ppg. Boise is laying over 3 td's, but at home we feel like their strong offense will be too much for Nev and they will pull away and win by over 4 td's.

ARIZONA ST by 4 over Ucf - UCF snapped a 5 game losing streak last week vs Ariz, as they won 56-12 (602-261 yard edge) while Ariz St is surprisingly sitting at 6-2 on the season and last week went to Okla St and led just 21-14 HT (279-167 yd edge) but outscored Okla St 21-7 2H and won 42-21 (+259 yds). UCF's offense is led by their strong rush attack (272, 6.1) and RB Harvey has 1,201 yards (7.0, 16 td), but Ariz St's run defense is only allowing 112 rush ypg (3.5) and overall their defense is holding foes to 94 ypg under their season average (#11 FBS!). UCF did make a change at Def Coord before last week and they held Ariz to 128 ypg under their average and they only allowed 5 total rush yards. They face an Ariz St rush offense led by RB Skat-tebo (1001, 5.8, 11 td) but the pass attack only avg's 207 ypg (60%). This is a tough trip for UCF and ASU has playing well, but we think this will be a close game and call this one at the line.

Colorado by 7 over TEXAS TECH - These teams have not met since CU was last in the B12 back in 2010 and they have split their 10 career meetings. Colorado is off a bye, and have been rolling as of late. The Buffs have covered 6 straight games and are 5-1 SU over that span. TT is playing for a 4th straight week and are off a massive upset last week at Iowa St, where they won 23-22 and RB Brooks scored the GW td with :20 left 4Q. Last season CU's DLine was a weakness, but they are allowing 155 (4.1) rushing and they have 22 sacks on the season. TT's defense is allowing 463 ypg/34 ppg in B12 play and their pass D is giving up 321 pass ypg in conf play and overall their pass D ranks #79 (62%, 20-11 ratio allowed). CU's strength is their passing game led by QB Sanders (73%, 21-6) and their top 4 WR's are all over 350 yds led by star WR/CB Hunter (757, 12.6). It is impossible to ignore CU's run right now and we will take the Buffs to win by a td.

UAB by 1 over UConn - First meeting. UConn is playing their first road game since Sept 14th. The Huskies are bowl eligible after beating Georgia St 34-27. They actually led that game 34-13 4Q. UAB entered last week's game vs Tulsa on a 6 game losing streak. The Blazers led Tulsa 45-0 at half and put up ssn highs of 59 points and 537 yards! UConn went back to Wisky transfer Nick Evers at QB but he only threw for 75 yards. RB Mel Brown was 14-138. UAB's Julien Kitina has thrown for 384 and 404 with an 8-1 ratio in their last two games. UConn is just 7-45 SU on the road the last 11 years but are favored here. UAB is 35-8 SU at home since '16 and we like the Blazers to pull the upset.

Marshall by 17 over SOUTHERN MISS - Former CUSA foes have not met as SBC foes and their last meeting came back in 2018. Marshall is 5-3 SU/6-2 ATS on the season while SMiss is 1-7 on the season and have yet to beat an FBS foe. SMiss has lost every game by at least 10 points and are -114 ypg/-15 ppg in SBC play, while Marshall is -41 ypg/+9 ppg in SBC play. Marshall is rushing for 232 ypg (5.7) in conf play and their OL has allowed just 8 sks. Their offense is led by RB Turner (766, 9.2) and QB Braxton gives this offense a dual-threat playmaker (9-1 ratio passing, 300 rush, 5.6 ypc). SMiss is allowing foes to gain 51 ypg above their season avg (#116) and they are allowing 229 rush ypg (5.4) in SBC play. Marshall has a huge edge on ST's (#52 vs #126) and given SMiss's struggles this season we'll lean with the Herd even though they are laying 2 td's.

Oklahoma by 4 over MISSOURI - Former Big 12 members meet again as SEC rivals. OK went 8-1 from '09-'11. The Sooners are 5-4 and off a 59-14 win over Maine. QB Jackson Arnold has a 5-0 ratio in their last 3 games and they did lead Ole Miss 14-10 two weeks ago. Mizzou is fresh off a bye and will likely be without QB Brady Cook again. We cashed a 3* going against Missouri two weeks ago in their 34-0 loss to Bama. Backup QB Drew Pyne is hitting 64% with a 0-3 ratio. The Tigers 26-6 SU at home including 5-0 this year but did have close wins against BC, Vandy and Auburn. Oklahoma has played the tougher sked (#13 vs #71), has the edge on D and their banged up WR corps is finally getting healthy. With Bama and LSU on deck, OK really needs a win here to get bowl eligible and we think their D shuts down a Mizzou offense that has struggled without Cook.

TULANE by 31 over Temple - Tulane won the last meeting in '20, 38-3 (-6') but Temple won 4 meetings from '14-'19. Temple is 2-6 and -74 ypg. The Owls are fresh off a bye and two weeks ago lost 56-34 at East Carolina. Tulane has won 6 straight including a 34-3 win over Charlotte last Thursday. Tulane has a huge edge on offense, putting up 426 ypg and 52 ypg more than their foes allow on avg (#34 in FBS). Tulane is avg just 321 ypg and is putting up 74 ypg less than their foes allow on avg (#126 in FBS). Tulane also has big edges on D (#30 vs #76) and ST's (#14 vs #63) and are at home laying nearly 4 td's. Under HC Drayton Temple is 0-14 SU/4-10 ATS on the road. Tulane has 4 wins by 31 points or more this year which is exactly where we put this line.

Texas St by 3 over ULM - TXSt has won 3 of the L/4 meetings SU and ATS. Last season TXSt (-17') trailed 20-9 in the 4Q but scored 2 times in the final 5 minutes to win 21-20. TXSt had high hopes for this season, but sit at just 4-4 on the season as all 4 of their losses are by 10 pts or less. ULM needs just 1 win to reach only their 2nd bowl game as an FBS team. They are +8 ypg/+15 ppg at home this season and are +5 TO's at home while they are -3 TO's and -131 ypg on the road. ULM is holding teams at home to 323 ypg at home. TXSt does have an explosive offense (450 ypg/33 ppg) but QB McCloud (68%, 20-7 ratio) left their last game with an ankle inj & is questionable. ULM is 9-4 ATS since 2021 as a home underdog with 7 outright upsets. While we won't call for the upset, we think ULM covers once again as a home dog.

NORTH TEXAS by 3 over Army - NT won the last two meetings but they haven't met since '17. The Mean Green are fresh off a bye and surely spent extra time prepping for the triple option. Army on the other hand has faced an extremely light schedule (#131). They've yet to face a top 50 QB this year and NT's Chandler Morris is #4 in the FBS with 2,873 pass yds and a 26-8 ratio. Army spent all of last week prepping to face their rival Air Force and the option. They were without QB Bryson Dailey and still won 20-3, easily cashing our 3* Totals Play on the Under, as part of our 4-0 Totals Day! This big concern here is how will NT's poor run D (225, 5.4 L/4) deal with Army's rush attack but with the extra prep and Daily either out or not 100%, we think North Texas will do enough to slow them down and Army has yet to see a pass attack like NT's so we are calling for the upset.

TCU by 14 over Oklahoma St - The home team in this series is on a 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS run and 5 of the L/6 meetings have gone 'Over' the Vegas total (avg 68 ppg). It has been a disappointing season for Okla St, as after starting 3-0 they have dropped 6 straight games (all B12 games). Okla St's rush D has been their big issue, as key inj's have hurt that unit. OSU is allowing 294 rush ypg (6.4) in B12 play and even worse have allowed 303 rush ypg (6.7) over the L/4 games. TCU does not run the ball well (103, 3.4) but could have some success here. TCU's pass attack is their strength (334 ypg) led by QB Hoover (67%, 21-8) and their top 4 WR's all have over 400 yds. Okla St's pass D ranks #74 (57%, 16-10) as they are allowing 230 pass ypg in conf play. Okla St's offense is only avg'g 354 ypg in B12 play and are only avg'g 106 rush ypg (3.7). The line is over DD's, but we will lean with TCU's strong offense to overpower OSU and win by 2 td's.

OREGON ST by 6 over San Jose St - Oregon St comes into this game off a bye week and sit at 4-4 on the season, but have dropped 3 games in a row. In their last game QB McCoy was benched for Ben Gulbranson, who started 7 games here in 2022. SJSt sits at 5-3 after coming into '24 with one of the least exp'd teams in the FBS. The Spartans are avg'g 325 pass ypg, but have been playing both Emmett Brown (58%, 16-5) and Walker Eget (58%, 2-5) at QB. Their star has been WR Nash who has 80 rec for 995 yds. OSU has played a much tougher schedule (#75 vs #123) and SJSt's defense has allowed foes to gain 38 ypg above their season avg (#106 FBS). Since 2021 OSU has gone 16-1 SU/13-4 ATS as a home favorite and are only laying around a fg. OSU had a bye to rest and recover from inj's and we like them to rebound at home.

WASHINGTON ST by 17 over Utah St - WSU is back at home and are off a bye week sitting at 7-1 on the season with the lone loss coming to Boise St on the road. Utah St is also off a bye week and sit at just 2-6 on the season. USU has had a great offense this season, led by QB Petras, who is hitting 66% with a 13-7 ratio and RB Faison leads with 797 (5.1). USU's problem has been their defense, allowing foes to gain 120 ypg above their season avg (#130 FBS). WSU's offense is putting up 448 ypg/38 ppg led by QB Mateer who is hitting 61% with an 18-6 ratio and also is the #1 rusher (575, 4.6). USU's run D is allowing 291 ypg (6.4) in the L/4 games and overall are giving up 542 ypg/47 ppg in their L/4 games. However WSU's defense is giving up 16 ypg above what their foes are avg'g (#92 FBS) and allow 424 ypg. We like WSU to get the win by DD's but are laying close to 3 td's and we think the Aggies offense can keep them within the number.

LOUISIANA by 17 over Arkansas St - Last season Ark St (+7) pulled the outright upset 37-17 and snapped a 5 game losing streak to the Cajuns. Ark St enters this game off a bye week and are still in the SBC West race, but need a win here to keep them in the hunt. LA played almost 2 weeks ago at TXSt and won 23-17 (+45 yds, +2 TO's). LA sits at 7-1 this season and their lone loss is to Tulane by 8 pts in a game they were +66 yds but -2 TO's. The Cajuns are led by QB Woodriddle who is hitting 69% with a 16-4 ratio and LA is rushing for 179 ypg (5.1). Ark St's defense is allowing foes to gain 69 ypg above their avg (#122 FBS) and are allowing 469 ypg over the L/4 gms and in those L/4 gms Ark St is all'g 194 rush ypg (4.9) and 68% completions. While we like the Cajuns to win by over 2 td's the line has jumped up over 2 td's so there isn't as much value on the Cajuns in this game.

MINNESOTA by 8 over Rutgers - Minny has won all 3 meetings as B10 foes, and in their last meeting back in '22 the Gophers (-14) held Rutgers to 134 yds and won 31-0 at home. Rutgers has suffered some inj's on defense and that has caused them to allow 490 ypg/40 ppg over their L/3 games. Rutgers is off a bye so they have had a chance to get healthier. Minn is off a big win and have now won 4 straight and are on a 4-0-1 ATS run in their L/5 games. Minn QB Brosmer is having a solid season, hitting 68% with a 13-4 ratio and Rutgers has the #83 pass D (64%, 10-5). Minn's defense is also playing well, holding foes to 77 ypg under their season avg (#22 FBS) and they have a huge edge on defense (#27 vs #80). Rutgers is off a bye and needing 2 wins for a bowl they will be playing tough, but Minn is rolling and we'll lean with them here.

OREGON by 28 over Maryland - Oregon is the top-ranked team in the country and come into this game +146 ypg/+22 ppg in their last 4 games and are fresh off a 38-17 win at Mich where they put up 470 yds, the most yds Mich has allowed all season. Maryland is off a bye week but their last game was a 25-point loss at Minn where they allowed 443 yds incl 320 pass yds. The Terps have the #80 pass D (60%, 15-10 ratio) and face Oregon QB Gabriel, who is hitting 75% with a 19-5 ratio and UO's OLine has allowed just 10 sacks on 295 pass attempts. Maryland does average 102 ypg above what their foes allow, however the Ducks also are holding foes to 83 ypg under their season avg (#19). Oregon has a big edge on offense (#4 vs #49) defense (#7 vs #87) and ST's (#9 vs #107). Maryland is just 1-16 SU/3-14 ATS as a road dog since 2018 and we like the Ducks to continue their dominance and win by 4 td's here.

PENN ST by 14 over Washington - Penn St is back at home this week, but are off their first loss of the season, falling 20-13 to Ohio St last week. Washington did get a big win over USC last week, but now head back on the road where they are 0-3 SU/ATS and their last 2 losses on the road are to 24 at Iowa and 14 at Indiana. Washington does have a solid defense and are allowing just 300 ypg in conf play and only 313 ypg on the road. PSU QB Allar played last week but was just 12-20 for 146 and an 0-1 ratio. PSU did hold Ohio St to 114 yds under their average and overall hold foes to 106 ypg under their average (#6 FBS). Washington does put up 405 ypg in B10 play and QB Rogers is hitting 71% with a 13-4 ratio, however Penn St's pass D ranks #18 (58%, 8-7 ratio). Washington's last 2 road games were at noon eastern, and now face Penn St in their annual whitout game. While we see PSU winning, this line is around 2 td's and Wash has a physical team and an exp'd QB with experience with hostile crowds.

UTEP by 7 over Kennesaw St - First meeting between two teams that have combined for a 2-15 SU record this year. UTEP has lost their last two but both were by 7 points or less. The offense has struggled under new HC Scotty Walden, putting up just 17 ppg and 319 ypg. KSU is avg just 15 ppg and 245 ypg. KSU did cover last week at WKU despite a 31-7 4Q deficit and needed a 4th and 12 QB run for first down on their final td. We trust UTEP a little more laying just a fg. These are two bad offenses so the Under could be a play but don't worry, it won't be the Totals GOY!

Jacksonville St by 7 over LOUISIANA TECH - Last year Jax St put up 42 points and 398 yds in the 1H and beat LA Tech 56-17 (-9) in the reg ssn finale. That was against a poor Bulldogs D that gave up 33 ppg and 418 ypg but this year they are #1 in CUSA, allowing just 20 ppg and 302 ypg. Jax St is off a huge win over Liberty but the 10 point margin is misleading as they were up 3 and had to stop Liberty at the JSU17 then got a Pick-6. LA Tech is off a 9-3 loss to Sam Houston. The Bulldogs are +44 ypg while JSU is +58 though Jax St has faced the tougher sked (#101 vs #130). Rich Rod is 6-1 ATS as a home favorite but LA Tech has been better at home and we like their stout defense to keep it closer than expected.

TENNESSEE by 27 over Mississippi St - Tenn is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS in this series but they haven't met since '19 when the Vols pulled the upset 20-10 (+6). Last week the Vols had 477 yards but dropped two td passes, missed 3 fg's and only beat KY 28-18 (-17'). Miss St team got a feel good win over UMass last week 45-20 (-18'). QB Michael Van Buren has a 9-4 ratio and has already faced the likes of Texas, Georgia and A&M's D's. Miss St has put up 31 ppg and 422 ypg in their L/4. However they've also given up 38 ppg and 492 ypg. Miss St's pass D is still the worst among P4 teams, allowing 72% and a 19-7 ratio and they also allow 212 rush ypg (5.3). Tenn's RB Sampson is #1 in the SEC with 982 (5.7) and just broke the school record with his 19th rush td. Under Heupel Vols are 9-4 ATS when favored by 3 td's or more. This is a battle between two offensive HC's. Heupel's teams have feasted on bad defenses and Miss St has scored points on some of the best in the SEC so this could be high scoring and the Vols will run their offense even with a big lead and backups in the game.

Wku by 17 over NEW MEXICO ST - WKU is out for revenge after losing LY's game at home 38-29 (-4). WKU has won 3 straight and is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS in CUSA play. Last week they were -24 against Kennesaw St and led 31-7 but gave up a 4th and 12 run which set up a td and the 'Toppers won by 17. NMSt has been much better at home this year than on the road. The Aggies nearly upset Liberty at home and both wins are at home including over LA Tech a few weeks ago. NMSt is -95 ypg at home but -247 on the road! WKU has their 3 biggest CUSA games ahead vs LA Tech/Liberty/Jax St. Helton is 22-11 ATS away but are laying nearly 20 points and we cut our line off at 17.

NOTRE DAME by 35 over Florida St - ND has won the last 3 meetings including a 28 pt win in '18 when they were -16'. The Irish have won 6 straight and have gotten distance on teams including two weeks ago when they we cashed a 4H LPS for us, beating Navy 51-14 (-14). They also have a 42 point win over Stanford and a 59 point win at Purdue this year. FSU is in the midst of a disastrous season as their numerous Portal additions haven't worked out. They have yet to reach 300 yards in a single game (avg 14 ppg and 262 ypg). Two weeks ago they lost at home to North Carolina 35-11 and were outgained 500-201. They did stay within 16 against Clemson, holding the Tigers to 7 fg attempts and only lost by 22 at Miami but also lost by 26 at SMU. ND is 15-3 ATS vs ACC foes including 3-0 this year and should have no problem against an unmotivated FSU team.

Clemson by 3 over VIRGINIA TECH - Clemson is 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS vs VTech and have won the last 3 in Blacksburg by 35, 14 and 20. The Tigers are in bounce back mode after a shocking home loss to Louisville where they were outgained 450-366. VT was without QB Drones and RB Tuten last week. They still led Cuse 14-3 at half but lost 38-31. The Hokies still need a win to get bowl eligible. Clemson is +135 ypg and +165 vs the ACC while VT is +23 ypg and +9 vs the ACC. Tigers have the edge on offense but VT has a huge edge on ST's (#18 vs #105). Clemson is still in the ACC race but needs help. VT has yet to win a close game in the last two seasons so we like Clemson to win but if VT is healthy they should keep it close.

Alabama by 6 over LSU - Bama travels to Baton Rouge where they lost in '22 32-31 as 13' pt chalk. LY Bama got revenge on LSU but the game was tied when LSU lost QB Jayden Daniels to injury. LSU has had trouble stopping offenses with dual threat QB's. They allowed 243 rush vs South Carolina. Two weeks ago they shut down A&M's offense until the Aggies switched to Marcel Reed and scored 31 points in 1.5 quarters. LSU allowed 242 rush yds (4.9) and QB Nussmeier also threw 2 costly int's in the 38-23 loss. Now they face Bama's Jalen Milroe who ran for a career high 155 yards on LSU's D last year. This is a night game in Baton Rouge and the stakes are high with the loser out of the playoff picture. We will take the mobile QB to run through the LSU defense.

Unlv by 13 over HAWAII - UNLV and Hawaii have traded wins in the L/4 meetings with the home team going 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS. UNLV last played over 2 weeks ago, as they hosted Boise St in a Fri Night showdown and led in the 4Q but lost 29-24. Hawaii has won 2 straight games and last week pulled the outright upset at Fresno, as they held a 346-176 yd edge. Hawaii's defense is holding foes to 27 ypg under their avg but have played the #118 schedule. UNLV has only put up 400+ yards in 1 of their L/4 games and in MW play the Rebels are just +13 ypg in MW play while Hawaii is +12 ypg in MW play. The key here is ST's ranking as UNLV is #1 while Hawaii is #100. We think the Rebels are the stronger team, but Hawaii has proven they are a tough team & we think this game finishes right around the line.

We have used the Lions as a ★ rated play on these pages 5 times (5-0) including twice as the top play & we will go back to them here! **FORECAST: Detroit by 14**

3★ ARIZONA over NY Jets - Ariz is on a 3 game win streak after their 29-9 win vs CHI last week, while the Jets snapped their 5 game losing last Thur vs Houston but were outgained and only put up 293 yds. The Jets do have a strong pass rush and they collected 8 sacks last week, but the Cardinals have allowed just 3 sacks the L/4 games as QB Murray is great at escaping the pocket. NYJ did allow 187 rush (5.2) to HOU last week and Ariz ran for 213 yards (6.3) last week. Ariz is led by RB Conner (664, 4.5) and Murray is the #2 rusher (350, 8.1). Ariz also collected 6 sacks in last week's game and here face less of a mobile QB and the Jets OL has been shaky at times. NYJ is avg'g just 298 ypg on the road and are -42 ypg on the road and have covered just 1 of their L/6 games. The line is almost at a pick'em and we like the streaking Cardinals to win and cover their 4th game in a row over a Jets team getting too much hype for getting one win against a beat up Texans team & they have been underwhelming all ssn. **FORECAST: Arizona by 13**

2★ LA CHARGERS over Tennessee - LAC comes into this meeting having won 3 of their L/4 games and their lone loss was on a last-sec FG on the road. TEN picked up their 2nd win of the season last week vs NE in OT. TEN's only 2 wins are vs a rebuilding Pats squad and a MIA team missing their starting QB. TEN has put up 400+ yds the L/2 games but they have been done in by TO's all season, as TEN is #31 in the NFL with a -11 TO ratio, while LAC is +9 in TO's! LAC is avg'g 265 pass ypg over the L/4 games and WR's Ladd McConkey and Quentin Johnston (118 yds last week) are emerging. LAC is #1 in the NFL allowing 12.6 ppg and they have 11 sacks over the L/2 games while TEN's QB options are either Mason Rudolph or Will Lewis and TEN might not have much success rushing the ball as LAC allows just 108 ypg (4.6). Cincy did throw for a season-high 371 yds vs BAL this season & the Ravens secondary is allowing 66% and 281 ypg. Cincy's worst game on DEF this ssn came vs BAL where they allowed 520 yds incl 345 pass yds.

† NY Giants by 7 over Carolina - Game in Munich, Germany. CAR got their 2nd win of the season last week vs a reeling Saints team 23-22 where they only put up 246 yds and allowed 427 yds as CAR held NOLA to 3 fg's on 3 long drives. NYG trailed 24-10 into the 4Q but 2 scores made this game closer (27-22) than it actually was as 154 of their 326 yds came on their 24Q scoring drives. NYG does have some playmakers on offense such as WR Nabers and RB Tracy and they will take on a CAR defense allowing foes to gain 72 ypg above their season avg (#31 NFL) and their pass D is allowing 70% and 233 ypg. NYG has a strong pass rush (35 sks) while CAR has just 10 sks. NYG has the higher upside and in a battle of 2 win teams we'll lean slightly with the G-Men.

Buffalo by 7 over INDIANAPOLIS - The 7-2 Bills head back on the road to Indy and face a Colts team here off a Sun Night loss at Minn where they went to QB Flacco but the offense only put up 227 yds and 13 pts. IND's defense is also allowing foes to gain 59 ypg above their ssn avg (#30 NFL) and BUF's offense is putting up 380 ypg/30 ppg in their L/4 games. IND's pass D allows 70% and 234 ypg and BUF QB Allen is hitting 64% with a 17-2 ratio. The Bills are also protecting the QB well, allowing just 11 sks in 9 games. BUF's defense has allowed 322 ypg over their L/4 gms, but they are allowing 71% completions & 224 pass ypg but only 98 rush ypg. The Bills defense struggled a bit getting MIA off the field last week, but their offense can move the ball. We think the Bills can get a timely stop or two and get this road win by one score.

Minnesota by 7 over JACKSONVILLE - Minn stopped their 2 game losing streak last week at home with a 21-13 win over Indy where they had a 415-227 yd edge. JAX was down 22-0 to the Eagles last week but came back to cut it to one score and ultimately lost by just 5 pts despite being outgained 447-215 and being -2 TO's. JAX continues to have one of the worst pass D's in the NFL, allowing 264 ypg and 71% completions. That again could be an issue facing the Vikings and star WR Jefferson who just went 7 rec for 137 yds last week & Minn also has WR Addison plus they got back TE Hockenson last week. WAS's defense is allowing just 324 ypg/19 ppg over their L/4 games, while the offense is putting up 391 ypg over the L/4 games and at home are putting up 440 ypg while holding teams to 251 ypg/13 ppg. WAS QB Daniels is hitting 72% with a 9-2 ratio and has 459 rush (5.6) but the Steelers allow just 91 rush ypg (4.0) but are allowing 265 pass ypg the L/4 games. TB still struggles to run the ball (127, 5.1) and SF does allow just 106 rush ypg (4.3). SF does struggle to defend the pass at times as they allowed 236 (66%) to Dallas 2 wks ago and earlier TY to SEA allowed 306 pass yds. TB QB Mayfield is hitting 71% still with a 23-9 ratio. Philadelphia by 10 over DALLAS - The home team in this NFC East clash is 9-1 SU/ATS. DAL enter this matchup in rough shape, as they have dropped 3 straight and now will be without QB Prescott for at least 4 games (inj'd). DAL will go with Cooper Rush at QB and they already struggle to rush the ball (82, 3.4) and their #1 WR Lamb is also dealing with an inj. Philly on the other hand has won 4 straight and have put up 389 ypg/15 ppg during that win streak. The biggest key to their win streak is their defense, allowing just 215 ypg/15 ppg and are +174 ypg/+14 ppg in the L/4 gms. DAL's defense is allowing 225 pass ypg (69%) this season and are without key stars on that side of the ball. PHI should win this game by DD's but will need to keep their foot on the gas if they get up early.

Miami vs LA RAMS - MNF - The Rams have turned their season around, winning 3 in row and cashed a 3★ winner on these pages as well as a 4★ LP play when they won 26-20 last week at SEA in OT. MIA's offense has looked much better (377 & 373 yds) in the 2 games since Tua returned at QB. Tua is hitting 80% the L/2 weeks & the Rams all'd 317 pass ypg/LW but did have 3 int's. However they have failed to get that timely stop as they allowed 325+ yds in each of their L/2 games after holding 5 of their F/6 foes to under 300 yds.
