Utah does have the #2 pass D (49%, 10-8) but QB Sanders is hitting 73% with a 24-6 ratio and has several talented WR's to throw to. CU is playing their best ball of the season & we'll back the Buffs here.

FORECAST: COLORADO by 24

3★ SOUTH CAROLINA over Missouri - Mizzou is 5-0 SU/ATS in this series. Tigers are +91 ypg but -60 ypg vs SEC foes. LW Mizzou was w/o QB Brady Cook. They trailed Oklahoma 23-16 but went 75/8 td then had a 17 yard fumble ret td with :22 left to win by 7. MO finished with just 278 yds. SC has won their L/3 and their SEC wins are by 21, 26, 24 & 25. Mizzou's 2 losses are by 34 and 41 points. These two have 4 common foes (A&M, Bama, Vandy & OK). MO is 2-2 SU/ATS and -14 ppg & -92 ypg while SC is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS, +17 ppg & +95 ypg. SC has played the tougher sked (#8 vs #69) and a win gives SC their first winning SEC record since '17. The Gamecocks have cashed 3★ Key Selections on these pages in each of their last two games and we are going back to them here as they are definitely in the mix for our College 5★ GOY!!!

FORECAST: SOUTH CAROLINA by 24

3★ ILLINOIS over Michigan St - Illinois enters this game off a bye week and have dropped 2 straight prior to starting 6-1. They host a Mich St team with just 3 wins on the season and are also off a bye, but in their last game went up 10-0 on Indiana before allowing 47 straight points. ILL is +43 ypg at home and play their best ball at home as they have wins over Kansas and Mich at home, and could have beat Minn 2 weeks ago but fumbled on the final poss. ILL is +8 TO's at home and take on a Mich St team -5 TO's on the road and QB Chiles has an 8-12 ratio and the MSU offense avg's just 334 ypg/17 ppg in B10 play and are -38 ppg in conf play. ILL QB Altmyer is hitting 63% with a 16-3 ratio and now takes on a defense that has not recorded a sack in 5 games and the pass defense has allowed 65% and 229 ypg in conf play. With the line only being around a fg we like ILL to get the win here by a couple of scores.

2★ NOTRE DAME over Virginia - The last time these two met was in '21 when we used the Irish -3' as our 5★ GOY and it was never in doubt as ND led 21-0 at half and won 28-3. ND has won 7 straight and covered their L/5. Last week they throttled FSU 55-3 (-25). ND is +138 ypg. UVA is only +2 ypg. Last week UVA was +7' and upset Pitt 24-19. The Cavaliers need 1 more win to get bowl eligible but have a better shot against SMU and at VTech the last 2 weeks. UVA has a 27 pt loss to NCar and a 17 pt loss to Clemson but trailed that game by 28 3Q. UVA has given up 31 sacks (10%) while ND has 26 including 8 last week. The Irish are on a ridiculous 17-2 ATS run vs the ACC. The luck of the Irish worked for us before, we will go back to Notre Dame for a 2★ Selection and this is another game in the mix for our 5★ GOY!

FORECAST: NOTRE DAME by 28

2★ OLD DOMINION over James Madison - Last season ODU (+20') nearly pulled off the outright upset at JMU, losing 30-27. ODU is off a bye week, and in their last game were the favorite at App St and lost despite being +102 yards (-3 TO's). Prior to that loss ODU won 2 straight SBC home games, upsetting TXSt 24-14 and handing GSthrn their only SBC loss of the season, winning 47-19 with QB Joseph throwing for 304 yards and 4 td's! QB Joseph is also the team's #2 rusher (454, 6.0). JMU is +93 ypg and 7-2 on the season, but have played the #128 schedule (ODU faced #53 schedule) and in their 2 SBC road games this season have lost to ULM 21-19 and GSthrn 28-14. ODU is 4-1 ATS the L/2 years as a home underdog and already have one outright home upset this season. This is still a talented JMU team, but are under a 1st year HC and ODU has the coaching edge here. We like the Monarchs to get another home upset.

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 13th

MIAMI, OH by 35 over Kent St - Kent St has lost last two in series including last year 23-3 (+14'). The home team is 8-2 SU/7-2 ATS since '13 and the Under is on a 9-1 ATS run in the series (avg 39 ppg). Kent St is now 0-9 SU/1-7-1 ATS this season and last week they were drilled at home by Ohio 41-0 (+19'). Miami, OH has won 4 straight but didn't cover last week against Ball St (27-21, +11'). The Redhawks are +86 ypg in MAC play while Kent St is -174. Last week the Golden Flashes started w/o QB Ruel Tominson and he finished 8-18 for 62 yards. Miami is 5-0 ATS as a MAC HF the last two years. Kent St has the worst D in the country, allowing 528 ypg and 156 ypg more than their foes avg. They are giving up 265 rush (5.9) and 263 pass (#133, 69%, 21-5). We can't imagine leaning with Kent St at this point but Miami is laying 31 points which is the most they've been favored by in a MAC home game since '03.

OHIO by 6 over Eastern Michigan - Ohio is 8-1 SU/7-2 ATS against EMich since 2002. The home team had failed to cover the L/4 gms and the L/3 games have been outright upsets. They last met in 2021 at EMich and the Bobcats were the underdog (+6) but pulled off the outright upset 34-26. EMich hasn't played in 11 days and last faced Toledo at home where got a hail mary pass on the final play, but then missed the game-winning 2-pt conversion. Ohio played last Wed at Kent and won easily 41-0 (407-114 yd edge) and Ohio also returned a kickoff and punt for a td. EMich is struggling to stop the run lately, allowing 218 ypg (4.8) the last 4 weeks and Ohio is rushing for 228 ypg (5.5) in MAC play and RB Tyus returned last week (694, 5.5) and QB Navarro is the #2 rusher (549, 6.1). However, EMich is in the preferred role as a MAC road underdog, where they are 27-8-1 ATS since 2016. EMich has put up 432 ypg in MAC play and we think they keep this game within one score.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 13 over Akron - NIU is 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS in this series since '09 but the home team is on a 1-6 ATS run. The Over has hit 4 straight in the series (avg 60 ppg). Last year NIU led 35-7 at half and finished with a ssn high 571 yards in a 55-14 (-5) win. The Huskies need 1 win to get bowl eligible and are coming off a 42-28 (-1) win over WMich. Akron will be home for bowl ssn at 2-7 and is -47 ypg vs MAC and -196 ypg on the road while NIU is +70 ypg vs MAC and +178 ypg at home. NIU is laying 18 points here and Thomas Hammock is just 5-15 ATS as a HF and the Huskies are 4-17 ATS as a favorite since '22. This is actually the largest NIU has been favored since Hammock's first year ('19) when they were -22' and beat Akron 49-0. NIU has a big game vs Miami OH on deck and our lean is with the underdog Zips.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 14th

East Carolina at TULSA - EC needs 1 more win to be bowl eligible. The Pirates have gone 2-0 SU/ATS since firing HC Mike Houston and they've put up 56 and 49 points against Temple and FAU. Mich St transfer QB Katin Houser has a 13-4 ratio and just threw for 343 yards and 5 td's vs FAU.

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Tulsa must win their last 3 to reach a bowl. Two weeks ago Tulsa was +2' and lost at UAB 59-21 and the week before they trailed 42-17 4Q but rallied to shock UTSA. They also have a 42 pt home loss to Army and 35 pt home loss to Okie St. Tulsa is on a 5-1 series ATS run with 4 straight wins but the Golden Hurricane are just 2-8 ATS at home under Wilson. Call 1-800-654-3448 to get our free Thursday Night Marquee.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 15th

COLORADO ST by 14 over Wyoming - Battle for the Bronze Boot. Wyoming is 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS in this series since 2016. Wyo is off a bye week and last game they were at NMex and put up 604 yds in a 49-45 win. Kaden Anderson is the new QB for Wyo and he was 20-29 for 342 and a 3-1 ratio. CSU is on a 4-game win streak SU and have covered 6 straight games. The Rams rush attack is avg'g 188 ypg (5.1) in MW play led by RB's Morrow (788, 6.1) and Marshall (477, 4.5) and Wyo is allowing 209 (6.3) in MW play and in their last game vs NMex gave up 412 rush yds (14.2!). Wyo also has the #74 pass D (60%, 13-5) and CSU QB Fowler-Nicolosi has a 5-1 ratio in the L/5 games. In the 2 games since switching to QB Anderson Wyo has put up 470 and 604 yds and ran for 276 (6.6) and 262 (4.9) but the Rams allow just 100 rush ypg (3.7). The Rams are also allowing 423 ypg/16 ppg in MW play and are +7 TO's in MW play. Wyo is -194 ypg on the road and we think the Rams win & cover streak continues with a win here by 2 td's!

UTSA by 3 over North Texas - UTSA has won the last 3 mtgs (2-1 ATS). LY UTSA was -7', led 27-13 at half and 37-21 4Q. They won 37-29. The home team is 9-2 SU/ATS in this series and NT has lost their last 3 trips to the Alamo Dome. NT started 5-1 but has lost 3 straight. Last week QB Morris threw 3 int's and NT failed to reach the EZ in a 14-3 (+4) loss to Army. NT's run D has gone backwards recently, giving up 241 (5.3) in their L/4. UTSA is only rushing for 135 (3.5) this year but they've run for 284 ypg in their L/5 mtgs. UTSA is 4-5 and fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they upset Memphis at home 44-36 (+7'), a game they actually led 44-24 4Q and allowed 2 td's in final 2 minutes. UTSA is 22-2 SU at home the last 4 years and 5-1 as a home dog. We like the Roadrunners to pull the upset.

WASHINGTON by 7 over UCLA - UCLA has won 7 of the last 10 meetings and have won & covered the past 2 meetings back in 2021 and 2022. This season's Bruins started 1-5 but have now won 3 straight games after 3 straight outright upsets at Rutgers, at Neb then last week vs Iowa. UW is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in true home games this season and are +173 ypg/+17 ppg at home. UCLA does have the #89 pass D (66%, 15-6) and UW QB Rogers is hitting 71% with a 13-5 ratio. Despite giving up 450+ yards in B2B games, UW is still holding foes to 77 ypg under their avg (#17) and at home are allowing just 283 ypg and 13 ppg. UCLA only averages 89 ypg rushing (3.2) and they are facing a UW pass D ranked #6 (51%, 6-5 ratio) and QB Garbers has just an 12-11 ratio. At home we like the Huskies to win by a td.

Houston by 6 over ARIZONA - HOU has won 3 of the previous 4 mtgs vs Ariz and the last one came in 2018 where the Cougars won 45-18 at home. HOU is off a bye and 2 weeks ago pulled a home upset over KSt despite being -95 yds as they came back from a 19-10 deficit to start the 4Q and won 24-19. HOU has won 3 of their L/4 games (all outright upsets) despite only avg'g 304 ypg in their L/4 games. HOU's DEF has been strong all season, as they are holding foes to 92 ypg under their season avg (#10 FBS!). As for offense HOU is led by QB Chriss and he was 11-11 and also ran for 75 yds. Ariz has dropped 5 straight games after starting 3-1 and they have only covered 1 of their 9 games this season. Ariz is only avg'g 320 ypg/16 ppg over their L/4 games and are -71 ypg/-16 ppg in B12 play & over the L/4 games are -130 ypg/-25 ppg. HOU also has the #38 pass D (61%, 14-8) to go against WR McMillian & QB Fifita. We like the Cougars to continue the losing streak for Ariz and get the win here as road underdogs.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 16th

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 14 over Troy - This is the first meeting since 2021 and GSthrn is 6-2 ATS since they became SBC foes. GSthrn comes into this game off a bye and are in the drivers seat to reach the SBC title game. GSthrn is avg'g 416 ypg in SBC play led by QB French (65%, 14-6) and he faces a Troy pass D ranked #113. Troy also allows 171 rush ypg (4.8) on the season and GSthrn has a solid 1-2 punch at RB in White and Arnold. Troy has just 2 wins on the season and on the road are -136 ypg. The Eagles also have a big edge on ST's (#38 vs #85) and they are 4-0 ATS at home this season. Troy lost to South Ala 25-9 (-146 yds) while GSthrn beat SAla 34-30 despite getting outgained by 121 yds (+2 TO's!). The Eagles need to keep winning to reach the title game and are a tough team at home, while Troy is in full rebuild mode and cannot reach a bowl game. We think the Eagles take this one by a couple scores.

MARSHALL by 16 over Coastal Carolina - Marshall is 0-2 SU/ATS vs Coastal as SBC foes and both times Coastal pulled the outright upset. The Herd are on a roll, winning 5 of their L/6 games and are t-#1 in the SBC East. They are also 7-2 ATS on the season. Coastal snapped a 3 game losing streak last week with a win vs App St, but are -105 ypg in SBC play and are -68 ypg on the road, and Marshall is +36 ypg in SBC play and +53 ypg at home. Coastal struggles to stop the run, allowing 211 ypg (5.0) in conf play and the Herd are avg'g 239 rush ypg (5.7) in conf play led by RB Turner (793, 9.2) and QB Braxton has a 10-2 ratio and is the #2 rusher (359, 5.4). Marshall also has a good pass rush, led by DE Michael Green who leads the FBS with 13 sacks! Three of MU's 4 conf wins are by 15+ points and Coastal has lost to JMU on the road by 32 pts (-240 yds) and Troy by 14 pts (-198 yds). We think the Herd stampede Coastal here by over 2 td's.

TEMPLE by 3 over Fau - First mtg. Both teams are staying home for bowl season. Both teams are 2-7. FAU is on a 4 game losing streak and -137 ypg play. Temple has lost two straight including LW at Tulane 52-6, outgained 589-158. Owls are -148 ypg in AAC play. These two have 3 common foes (Army, UConn & ECU). FAU is 0-3 SU/ATS, -29 ppg & -229 ypg while Temple is 0-3 SU/1-2 ATS, -20 ppg & -155 ypg. Temple has played the tougher sked (#67 vs #111) and has a big ST's edge (#63 vs #124). Temple QB Evan Simon has a 13-6 ratio and FAU has given up 20 pass td's. Temple looks like the better team and they are at home so we like the Owls by a fg.

Texas by 14 over ARKANSAS - Former SWC rivals meet for the first time as SEC rivals. Arkansas won the last two meetings including in '21, 40-21 (-6'). Arkansas is fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago QB Taylen Green was banged up and Ark's secondary was shredded by Ole Miss in a 63-31 (+7') loss to Ole Miss. Ark allowed 694 yards including 562 passing. Tulsa pulled away from a depleted Florida team last week to win 49-17 (-22). The Longhorns D actually allowed a ssn high 329 yards but it was 42-0 before FL got on the board. Green is expected to return for Arkansas. Texas has a big edge on D, holding foes to 251 ypg and 122 ypg below their avg while Ark is allowing 387 ypg but 436 in SEC play. Pittman is 20-8 ATS as a dog but Ark has been crushed by 24 and 32 at home vs LSU and Ole Miss so we are taking Texas by 2 td's which is right at the line.

NORTH CAROLINA by 4 over Wake Forest - The home team is 9-3 SU/ATS in the series and NC has won 3 straight but all 3 were by 6 or less and WF covered the L/2. WF needs 2 wins to be bowl eligible while NC needs 1. Last week WF (+) was outgained 350-130 in the 1H at Cal and trailed 29-14. They did get within 3 but allowed a td w/1:10 left and lost by 10. NC returns home where they've lost 3 straight but the Heels won B2B road games, beating UVA by 27 (428-288 yds) & FSU by 27 (500-201 yds). Heels D is allowing just 16 ppg/282 ypg on the road but 35 ppg/432 ypg at home this year. WF has won all 3 road games this year, beating NCSt, UConn & Stanford. Deacons are +18 ypg on the road and -48 ypg at home while NC is +115 away but only +58 at home. NC is 3-13 ATS including 7 outright losses as a DD favorite and on an 0-6 ATS run at home while WF is 14-8 as a road dog. All signs say take the points and we agree!

CHARLOTTE by 3 over USF - Last year was first mtg, won by USF 48-14 (-7) in the ssn finale. USF is 4-5 while CLT is 3-6 and both teams still have bowl hopes with weak closing schedules. USF is 4-0 SU/ATS against tms with a losing record but 0-5 SU/1-4 ATS vs tms with a winning record. CLT is 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS vs tms with a losing record but 1-6 SU/3-4 ATS vs tms with a winning record. CLT is -55 ypg vs AAC foes while USF is -108. CLT did dominate East Carolina at home and USF's 23 point win at FAU is misleading. We will take the home team by a fg.

Liberty by 10 UMass - These two have met each year since '18. UMass won the first meeting but Liberty has won the last 5. UMass was +26 last year and were down 49-10 but scored 2 td's with their last td coming with :56 left for a backdoor cover. Liberty was coming off B2B losses last week and trailed Middle Tenn 7-0 but led 27-7 w/a 323-84 yd edge at half and won 37-17 (-11). UMass is fresh off a bye and two weeks ago lost at Miss St 45-20 (+18) two weeks ago. Liberty is 1-14 ATS when favored by 2 td's or more. UMass has covered their last 5 as double-digit dogs vs G5 foes. Liberty still has a shot at the CUSA Title game and has huge games against WKU and Sam Houston on deck so our lean is with the underdog.

WKU by 17 over Louisiana Tech - WKU has won the last two meetings including last year 35-28 (-6) and they led that game 35-7 at half. "Toppers are unbeaten in CUSA play but still have tough games vs Liberty and Jax St on deck. LT has lost two straight close games to SH & Jax St. Last week they were beating Jax St 37-31 but allowed a 49-yd Hail Mary on the games final play then lost in OT. WKU is 7-2 and their two losses were to Bama and BC (led 20-7 at half). Last week WKU was -17" and led NMSt 41-21 4Q but gave up a 29 yd td pass with 1:55 left and only won by 13. "Toppers are +85 ypg vs CUSA foes 6-3 ATS on the season. LT is +45 ypg vs CUSA foes and is 3-0 ATS as a dog this season. They've also lost all 4 road games by just 6.5 ppg but WKU is on a roll and was dominating this game early last year so our lean is with the home team.

WEST VIRGINIA by 4 over Baylor - Since 2018 WVU is 4-2 SU/ATS against Baylor. Last time hosting Baylor in '22 they were a slight underdog (+3) and pulled the outright upset. Baylor has averaged 531 ypg/45 ppg over their last 3 games including rushing for 285 ypg (7.4). WVU though has allowed just 120 rush ypg (3.5) over the L/4 games and overall in B12 play allow just 127 rush ypg (3.7). WVU forced 3 TO's last week and returned a fumble and INT for scores and kicked a fg off the 3rd TO vs Cincy. Baylor's defense has been shaky of late, as they have allowed 469 ypg/35 ppg over their L/4 games including allowing 320 pass ypg (68%). WVU is at its best when it can run the ball, and they have RB's White and Donaldson healthy and average 190 rush ypg (4.8) and QB Marichol is a runner. There is a chance Garrett Greene could play, but if not Marichol is a capable player. WVU is a small home dog & we think they pull the upset here.

Tulane by 17 over NAVY - Navy has won 6 of their last 7 meetings but they haven't met since '20 and Tulane did cover their last 3 trips to Annapolis. Tulane has had a double-digit lead in every game during their current 7 game winning streak. Last week the Green Wave led Temple 28-0 with a 310-72 yd edge at half and won 52-6. Navy ended a 2 game losing streak last week by beating USF 28-7 but only had a 379-342 yd edge. Tulane is +184 ypg vs the AAC while Navy is -10 vs the AAC and Tulane has also played the tougher sked (#76 vs #105). Tulane HC Jon Sumrall brought DC Greg Gasparato with him from Troy. Gasparato was Co-DC at Army in '20 and Sumrall's Troy teams beat Army 19-0 last year and 10-9 in '22. Tulane has the edge in all 3 phases including a huge ST's edge (#13 vs #112). Their DC knows how to stop the option and we feel there is great value with Tulane only laying a touchdown!

Clemson by 17 over PITTSBURGH - These two have split 4 ACC meetings since '16 and Pitt won the last meeting in '21 27-17 (-3). Clemson won in Blacksburg last week 24-14 and finished with a 378-228 yd edge. VT's two td's came on a blocked fg return and in garbage time. Pitt started the season 7-0 but had 3 fortunate wins and now they've lost 2 straight. QB Eli Holstein was injured again last week and bkp Nate Yarnell threw 2 int's in Pitt's 24-19 (-7) loss to Virginia. Holstein may return this week but he will have to deal with a Clemson D that allows just 54% completions and is holding foes 44 ypg below their avg. Pitt is avg 428 ypg but just 310 in their L/4 and the Panthers are -58 ypg in their L/4 while Clemson is +190 despite the loss to Louisville. Clemson had a 38-10 lead on that same Virginia team that beat Pitt LW. The Tigers still have a shot at the ACC Title game but must win out and we take the road favorite laying 10 pts.

Ohio St by 28 over NORTHWESTERN - Game at Wrigley Field. Since 2005 Ohio St is 10-0 SU/7-3 ATS vs NW, but in their last meeting in 2022 Ohio St (-38) was here on a windy day and was actually -2 yds in a 21-7 win. OSU got past Purdue 45-0 last week (+227 yds) and are now 8-1 on the season and are holding foes to 140 ypg under their avg (#1 FBS) and on offense are putting up 111 ypg above what their foes allow (#4 FBS). NW is -133 ypg in Big 10 play, but only -8 ppg and at home are just -19 ypg/2 ppg. In the L/2 seasons NW has not lost a game by more than 4 td's and the line here is over that mark. While OSU will win this game, they have 2 big games on deck vs Indiana and Mich and NW is a scrappy team that will cover this large spread.

Arkansas St by 6 over GEORGIA ST - As SBC foes Ark St is 6-2 SU/5-3 ATS but these teams have not met since 2021 here where Ark St (+15) was outgained 434-270 but only lost 28-20. After upsetting Vandy at home to get to 2-1, GST has lost 6 games in a row SU (1-4-1 ATS). The L/4 games GST is -65 ypg/-15 ppg and are allowing 426 ypg incl 236 rush ypg (6.2). Ark St has

found their offense a bit over the past 4 games, putting up 447 ypg incl rushing for 212 ypg (5.5). Ark St does struggle on defense, allowing foes to gain 79 ypg above their season avg (#126 FBS). However GST's offense gets held to 111 ypg under what their foes allow (#91). GST is also -85 ypg in SBC play and Ark St has the big St edge (#22 vs #90). GST only has 2 wins with 3 games left to play, so cannot make a bowl, while Ark St needs one more win to hit six wins. GST is the favorite as of presstime, but we see Ark St as the stronger team & we think they win the game outright.

MARYLAND by 6 over Rutgers - Maryland has won and covered each of the L/3 meetings, winning by an avg of 26 pts. MD is off a 39-18 loss at Oregon where they were only -74 yds. Rutgers got back in the win column last week with a 26-19 win vs Minn where they held the Gophers to 297 yds. MD's offense is putting up 89 ypg above what their foes allow (#18) but Rutgers defense is getting healthier and showed improvement last week. MD is -45 ypg/-15 ppg in B10 play while Rutgers is -85 ypg/-10 ppg. MD has played the tougher schedule (134 vs #59) but since 2020 Maryland is just 3-7 ATS as a B10 home favorite and we'll call for this one to finish right at the line.

Penn St by 34 over PURDUE - Penn St has won the L/10 meetings SU (7-3 ATS) and the home team is on a 1-9 ATS slide in the series. Penn St is off their white out game where they dominated Wash 35-6 (486-193 yd edge). Purdue was at Ohio St and lost 45-0 but did move the ball some on a stingy OSU DEF. PSU's defense is holding foes to 116 ypg under their avg (#3 FBS) and are only allowing 290 ypg in B10 play. Purdue has avg'd just 281 ypg and 7 ppg in their L/3 games and on defense allow foes to gain 104 ypg above their avg (#128 FBS). Purdue hosted Oregon off their big win vs Ohio St and Purdue still lost 35-0 and PSU is off a big win of their own, but we see no issues with PSU being able to cover this large spread as Purdue is the worst team in the B10.

AUBURN by 28 over ULM - Auburn is 14-0 SU/7-6 ATS vs current SBC foes since '00. Tigers are also 11-0 SU vs ULM all-time and won the last meeting in '17, 42-14. ULM started 5-1 but still needs 1 more win to be bowl eligible, coming off 3 straight losses. Auburn will surely be reminded of LY's embarrassing loss to NMSt. The Tigers still have a shot at a bowl but must beat A&M and Bama. Auburn is +105 ypg but are 3-6 largely thanks to -10 TO's. ULM is -68 ypg and this is their 2nd game vs an SEC foe, losing 51-3 at Texas in Sept. Auburn needs a feel good win. ULM just lost to Texas St by 21 and a few weeks ago lost by 29 at South Alabama. We think Auburn clears the 24 point spread but their 10-19-1 ATS record as a 20+ HF gives us pause.

LOUISIANA by 14 over South Alabama - Since 2016 LA is 7-1 SU/5-3 ATS and last season the Cajuns (+11) pulled the outright upset 33-20 (-150 ypg but +5 TO's). The 'Under' is also 9-2 in the L/11 meetings (avg 48 ppg). The Cajuns are off a 55-19 blowout win over Ark St, where they were +178 yds & +2 TO's. SALA is 4-5 on the season and are putting up 445 ypg/33 ppg in SBC play and are rushing for 236 ypg (5.9) in SBC play. However SALA is -43 ypg on the road, while the Cajuns are +114 ypg at home and in SBC play are +109 ypg. SALA has the #79 pass D (64%, 13-11) and the Cajuns QB Wooldrige is hitting 69% with a 17-4 ratio and their top 3 RB's all have over 400 yds and all are rushing for at least 5.8 ypc. The Cajuns defense does hold foes to 31 ypg under their avg and they have a ST edge (#21 vs #69). SALA has played well this season, but the Cajuns are the top team in the SBC West & we like LA by 2 td's here.

Washington St by 10 over NEW MEXICO - WSU enters this game 8-1 on the season with their lone loss coming at Boise St and are +31 ypg/+12 ppg on the season. NMex has gotten to 4 wins under 1st year HC Mendenhall and their offense is putting up 514 ypg over the last 7 games led by QB Dampier, who has thrown for 2,418 yards (59%) and is the #1 rusher (858, 7.4). However, the Lobos defense is allowing foes to gain 123 ypg above their season avg (#133 FBS). WSU does put up 452 ypg/29 ppg led by QB Mateer (2232, 62%, 22-6 ratio) who is also the team's #1 rusher (630, 4.6). WSU's defense is a bit better, but they are allowing foes to gain 133 ypg above their average (#89). NMex is 3-1 ATS this season as a DD underdog and are potent enough on offense to keep this game within the spread.

BYU by 7 Kansas - BYU enters this game still as the lone unbeaten team in the Big 12 and they escaped last week at Utah with a 22-21 win where they benefitted from a couple ? calls on their final fg drive. Kansas meanwhile beat up on Iowa St last week 45-36 where they led 31-13 HT and put up 532 yards led by RB Neal (116, 6.4). KU did allow 461 yds incl 383 pass yds and BYU QB Retzlaff has 2,089 pass yds on the ssn with a 17-7 ratio. In their L/2 road games KU's run D has allowed 313 (7.0) to Ariz St and 226 (5.9) to Kan St and here they face a BYU rush attack that has averaged 194 (5.3) the last 4 games led by RB's Martin (425, 5.7) and Ropati (322, 5.6). BYU holds foes to 74 ypg under their avg (#20 FBS) and they have the #1 pass D in the country (52%, 10-16 ratio) and KU QB Daniels is hitting just 56%. This is a night game in Provo and since 2021 KU is just 6-12 ATS as a road underdog of at least 3 pts and they will have to face the elevation too. BYU just keeps finding ways to win and we have them grabbing another one-score win here.

JACKSONVILLE ST by 14 over FIU - This is FIU's first trip to Jax St. Last year was the first mtg, won by Jax St 41-16 (-9). FIU is 3-6 but has winnable games in their last 2 so a bowl is possible if they pull the upset. Jax St has won 6 straight but needed a miracle to beat LA Tech last week, getting a 49 yd Hail Mary td pass, missing the PAT then won in OT 44-37 (-8). The Gamecocks are +24 ypg vs CUSA foes while FIU is actually +9 vs CUSA foes and come in fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago FIU only led NMSt 7-6 at half but won 34-13. Jax St is rushing for 342 (5.8) ypg in CUSA play while FIU is allowing 210 (4.6) in their L/4. Jax St has two huge games on deck vs SH and WKU and FIU only lose to Liberty by 7 in OT. We are right at the line and see reasons to like both sides.

Louisville by 24 over STANFORD - First meeting between the Cardinal and the Cardinals. UL is fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they beat Clemson 33-21 (-10"). Stanford is also fresh off a bye and in the midst of a miserable run, having lost 6 straight by 26 ppg/-149 ypg. This is Stanford's home finale and two weeks ago they made their 4th trip to the ETZ and lost 59-28 at NCSt, outgained 527-398. Despite the winning record, UL is still -29 ypg vs the ACC foes while Stanford is -106 and -194 L/W. UL is 7-10 ATS as a double-digit favorite but they've covered all 3 in that role this year. Stanford is 5-13-1 ATS as a home dog since '21 and we would rather lay the points with the more talented team.

Now the Beavers have to travel to the altitude and are catching AF off their best performance of the season & have to contend with the option. AF has also allowed under 290 yds in each of their L/2 games and overall are holding teams to 28 ypg under their avg. Air Force is again getting points at home on senior day and with the Beavers having high hopes for the season and those being gone, we wonder what kind of effort they will give here, while we know a service academy team will play hard regardless of the situation & we like AF to get another home upset! **FORECAST: AIR FORCE by 6**

Sam Houston by 17 over KENNESAW ST - Two recent additions to the FBS meet for the 3rd time. LY SH was -17' but only won 24-21. HC Brian Bohannon started KSU's program 10 years ago but was dismissed this week despite KSU being more competitive than some expected and they even upset Liberty as 28 point dogs. Last week they were +4' and took UTEP to OT but lost 43-35 and were outgained 453-300. SH has only scored 19 points in their last two games but won both. QB Hunter Watson has been banged up but should be closer 100% coming off their bye week. FL is +75 ypg in CUSA play while KSU is -153. We don't know where KSU's head will be after letting Bohannon go so we are taking SH to cover.

CALIFORNIA by 14 over Syracuse - These two have only met twice, back in 1967-68. Cuse is traveling over 2,200 miles for their road finale. The Orange did win at UNLV earlier this year. Last week Cuse was +3 at BC. They trailed 14-0 2Q but led 21-14 3Q and finished w/a 431-378 yd edge but lost 37-31. Kyle McCord has 12 int's including 5 at Pitt a few weeks ago. Now he has to deal with a Cal D that leads the nation with 17 int's led by Nohl Williams who leads the FBS with 7 int's. Cal needs 1 more win to reach a bowl and all four of their losses have been by 5 points or less. Last week they put up a ssn high 500 yards and beat WF 46-36 (-7). Cal also has a huge ST's edge here (#23 vs #131). Syracuse has already lost to former Pac-12 member Stanford earlier this year. Cal is +122 ypg in their L/4 while Cuse is +33. We like the matchup for Cal and expect them to force turnovers and win by 2 td's.

UTAH ST by 7 over Hawaii - Utah St is on a 7-0 SU/6-1 ATS run against Hawaii dating back to 2011. USU has only won 2 games all season, but have a potent offense led by QB Petras, who is hitting 65% with a 15-8 ratio and WR Royals is his top target (54 rec, 834, 15.2). Hawaii has the #106 pass D (65%, 14-4) and Utah St averages 356 pass ypg (67%) in MW play. The Aggies downfall has been their defense, as they are allowing foes to gain 114 ypg above their avg (#132 FBS) and allow 542 ypg/47 ppg in MW play. Hawaii's offense is getting held to 49 ypg under what their foes allow (#114 FBS) and have only faced the #110 schedule and average just 329 ypg vs FBS foes. Hawaii did just pull an outright road MW upset to weeks ago at Fresno, but here they are a road favorite in MW play and when they were in that role last season at NMex (-2) they lost 42-21 and were -4 TO's. Hawaii does have to travel to the altitude and could be dealing with cold temps as well, and we like the Aggies offense to get rolling here & get the outright win at home!

SMU by 21 over Boston College - This is a rematch of LY's Fenway Bowl won by BC 23-14 (+12) but that game was played in cold weather. Now SMU gets BC in their house and is out for revenge. The Mustangs just need to win out to lock up a spot in the ACC Title game. The Eagles are 5-4 and beat Syracuse last week 37-31 (-2). QB Castellanos was benched in favor of Grayson James and BC threw for just 65 yards in the game. O'Brien named James the starter and Castellanos has left the team. The Eagles have given up 373 ypg but 441 in their L/4 and are -95 ypg in their L/4. SMU is fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they played their best game when they led Pitt 48-11 4Q before Pitt added 2 garbage td's. SMU is 8-2 ATS as a HF the L2Y and the Mutangs have a huge ST's edge (#4 vs #123) so we will go with the home team by 3 td's in a revenge game.

TEXAS ST by 35 over Southern Miss - In LY's meeting TXSt led 42-10 HT (351-188) but allowed SMiss to comeback and cut it to 42-36 mid 4Q before a late TXSt td put the game away 50-36. TXSt did go to ULM last week, which has been a tough place for SBC tms, but were +120 yds and +2 TO's in a 38-17 win where they ran for 326 yds (6.0). SMiss has just 1 win (vs FCS SELA) and have an interim HC and their coaches and players are likely looking ahead to next season. SMiss last week only put up 183 yds & 8 FD's in a 37-3 loss vs Marshall where they allowed 526 yds. TXSt still has plenty to play for and last week true frosh backup QB Brad Jackson came in and ran for 126 yds (7.4). TXSt's pass rush has 27 sks on the season and could have a big day facing a SMiss OL that has allowed 35 sks including 20 sks in their L/3 games! The line is close to 4 td's, but things could get ugly for SMiss in San Marcos & we like the Bobcats by 5 td's.

GEORGIA by 7 over Tennessee - Georgia has won the last 7 meetings and are 5-0 ATS in the series. They've held the Vols to their ssn low yards in each of the L/2 mtgs, allowing 277 and 289. Bulldogs led Ole Miss 7-3 last week but never got the offense going and were fortunate to only lose 28-10 (-2). Tenn's offense avg 472 ypg but has been mistake prone. Vols are #121 in RZ %. UGA's D is holding foes 110 ypg below their avg. Tenn's D has yet to allow 20 points in a game and they are holding foes 98 ypg below their avg. Vols QB lamaleava sat out the 2H of LW's 33-14 (-25) win over Miss St and reports are coming out that he is in Concussion protocol but Heupel is hopeful he will play. Vols defense will keep them in this but we actually give Bulldogs a small edge in all 3 phases so they win a close game.

IOWA ST by 7 over Cincinnati - After starting the season 7-0, ISU has dropped their last 2 games, and last week their defense was gashed for 532 yds and 45 pts at Kansas. Cincy is also on a 2-game losing streak, and last week did outgain WVU 436-248 but turned the ball over 3 times incl a fumble return for td and a pick-six in a 31-24 loss. Cincy does have a solid offense led by RB's Kiner (783, 5.3) and Pryor (350, 8.8) plus QB Sorsby is hitting 66% with a 16-5 ratio, and also has 192 rush and 7 td's. ISU's offense has played well in conf play, putting up 459 ypg/31 ppg and last week QB Becht threw for a season-best 383 yds (65%, 3-1 ratio) and when they have success on offense, they are able to run the ball (184, 4.6 in B12 play). The ISU defense has stumbled a bit, allowing 417 ypg/30 ppg over the L/4 games and while we feel like the Cyclones are the better team, Cincy finds a way to stay in games & we think this is a one-score game.

MEMPHIS by 10 over Uab - Memphis won the last two meetings by 24 & 37 points. It looked like UAB was about to win their 2nd straight last week. They had a 20-3 lead at half vs UConn but lost 31-23. Memphis 8-2 but only beat Rice 27-20 (-9) last week though they did have a 14 point lead until 1:55 4Q. The Tigers last 3 home wins have all come by 8 points or less. UAB is -43 ypg vs the AAC but in their last 3 games they are +94 ypg. Memphis is +47 ypg vs the AAC. Memphis is 0-5 ATS as an AAC home favorite so we like the underdog Blazers to keep it closer than expected.

Lsu by 1 over FLORIDA - LSU is 5-0 SU/ATS in this series and the last 6 have gone Over the Total (avg 74 ppg). The underdog has pulled the upset in 6 of the last 8 meetings. Both teams come in off a loss. LSU was no match for Bama last week in a 42-13 loss and LSU's only td came with :11 left. FL was w/o QB DJ Lagway and 3 key DB's. They started w/o Yale transfer Aidan Warner against Texas and trailed 35-0 at half and 42-0 3Q, scoring 17 points after the game was decided. FL is a dangerous underdog if healthy. They outplayed Tenn but lost in OT then led Georgia even after Lagway's injury but lost by 14. LSU has struggled with mobile QB's so if Lagway is healthy we think Florida could pull this upset so our lean is with the Gators and we will monitor the injuries.

KANSAS ST by 17 over Arizona St - Kansas St enters this game off a bye and are off a loss at Houston despite holding a 327-232 yd edge. They welcome in a 7-2 Ariz St team who won last week despite getting outgained 406-260 as they got a blocked punt return td & a pick-six. Ariz St was without top offensive player RB Skattebo last week (? as of presstime) but they are only +29 ypg in B12 play and both losses this season came on the road at Texas Tech and at Cincy, a game they trailed 24-7 at HT. KSt is led by their strong rushing attack and RB Giddens leads with 995 (6.1) and QB Johnson is the #2 rusher (391, 5.4) and Johnson is hitting 61% with a 17-7 ratio. In conf play this season KSt is +88 ypg and at home are +132 ypg. The Wildcats are 13-3 SU/ATS as a home favorite vs Big 12 opponents since 2020 and the Sun Devils will be traveling to the midwest where it will be colder temps at night. We feel like Ariz St is not as good as their record indicates and KSt has a huge ST edge (#43 vs #119). We'll take the Wildcats at home by over 2 td.

Boise St by 21 over SAN JOSE ST - Dating back to 2001 Boise St is 14-1 SU but just 8-7 ATS and have failed to cover each of the L/4 meetings. Boise is now 8-1 on the season, but did only beat Nev by 7 pts last week, but are outgaining conf foes by 130 ypg and SJSSt is +50 ypg in MW play. SJSSt is allowing 151 rush ypg (3.6) but have allowed 190 (5.3) to Nev and 186 (4.8) Colo St and here face a Boise rush attack putting up 269 ypg (6.7) led by Heisman hopeful RB Ashton Jeanty (1734, 7.7, 23 td) and the OL has allowed just 7 sacks all season. QB Madsen is hitting 62% with a 18-3 ratio and with teams stacking the box to stop the run, he can take advantage of 1-on-1 matchups. SJSSt does average 332 pass ypg but will take on a Boise pass rush with 39 sacks (#2 FBS). SJSSt does have much of a home field edge & Boise fans could actually outnumber SJSSt fans, plus we feel like Boise's close win and SJSSt's upset win last week gives us some value here & we'll back the Broncos to win by 3 td's.

USC by 6 over Nebraska - USC enters this game 4-5 and are in danger of missing a bowl. Neb is looking for win #6 as they started 5-1 this season but have dropped 3 in a row. USC is making the switch to transfer QB Jayden Maiava, who has just 11 pass att on the season, but HC Riley is hoping he can spark the offense. However Neb does hold foes to 77 ypg under their avg (#18) and they are allowing just 335 ypg in Big 10 play. Neb's offense the L/4 games has been an issue (290 ypg/15 ppg) but USC is allowing 439 ypg over the L/4 gms. USC does have the schedule edge (#12 vs #52) but this Neb DLine is tough and we think they can keep this game within the line.

Oregon by 10 over WISCONSIN - Last met in the '20 Rose Bowl with UO winning 28-27. UO is still unbeaten after beating MD last week 39-18 and the Ducks are +163 ypg in B10 play and are holding foes to 87 ypg under their season avg (#13 FBS). Wisconsin is off a bye and it was good timing for the Badgers as they dropped their previous 2 games prior to the bye week to Penn St by 15 and Iowa by 32 pts. Wisconsin is holding foes to 54 ypg under their average and in B10 they are +56 ypg and at home are +82 ypg. The Badgers led Penn St at HT at home this ssn and were playing even with Bama in the 1H until a few big plays turned the game. This game is a home game at night for the Badgers, and figure to have a fired up crowd on hand for this one and the Ducks are laying over 2 td's. The Ducks still get the win, but the Badgers will not make it easy on them.

TEXAS A&M by 45 over New Mexico St - A&M is 11-0 SU/4-7 ATS in non-conf November games since '12. A&M won the only prior meeting in '16, 52-10 (-44). They have big games against Auburn and Texas on deck. NMSt has been competitive at home but dreadful on the road, losing by 21 at FIU, 41 at Jax St, 20 at Sam Houston and 48 at Fresno. NMSt is -247 ypg on the road. A&M is 7-3 ATS when favored by over 40 points but failed to cover against McNeese earlier this year, laying 48' and won by 42. NMSt does have an SEC caliber RB in Seth McGowan (626, 5.2) and they've rushed for 228 (5.0) in their L/4 but it's hard to see them getting many FD's so A&M can name the score.

UNLV by 20 over San Diego St - Since 2014 UNLV is just 1-8 SU but have covered 5 of 9 meetings including 4 of the L/5 (all as a dog). This is the first time UNLV is favored against the Aztecs since 2009. UNLV survived a trip to Hawaii last week, winning 29-27 and got their 6th blocked punt of the season, which resulted in a safety, which was the difference in the game. SDSt has dropped 3 straight and last week allowed 475 yds to NMex in a 21-16 loss. The Aztecs are allowing foes to gain 25 ypg above their avg (#98) and on defense SDSt is allowing foes to gain 89 ypg above their avg (#130). UNLV's offense puts up 457 ypg in MW play led by QB Williams (64%, 13-3 ratio, 617 rush, 6.2) and WR White (799, 13.8, 10 td) but UNLV is just +33 ypg in MW play while SDSt is -117 ypg. UNLV has the #1 ST in the FBS and while we think they get the win, this line is around 3 td's and SDSt only has one loss larger than that.

2★ Kansas City over BUFFALO - The Bills have won the L/3 reg ssn mtgs vs KC (all at Arrowhead) but the Bills have lost in the playoffs to KC in 3 of the L/4 seasons. BUF comes on riding a 5 game win streak (4-1 ATS) and they are off a 30-20 win at Indy last week where they put up 415 yds & were +2 TO's incl a pick-six. KC just keeps finding ways to win as they blocked a DEN FG attempt on the final play of the game to win 16-14 and preserve their unbeaten season. KC is doing it with defense this ssn, allowing just 290 ypg and holding foes to 69 ypg under their season avg (#1 NFL!). KC's offense is putting up just 337 ypg/25 ppg over the L/4 games and BUF is allowing just 314 ypg/17 ppg the L/4 games. BUF is allowing 74% completions the L/4 gms and Mahomes is hitting 70%. BUF could also be down their top 2 WR's and TE Kincaid is ? as well. KC QB Mahomes is 11-3 SU/12-1-1 ATS as an underdog in his career incl a playoff win here last season and we aren't going to be the ones betting against KC here. **FORECAST: Kansas City by 6**

OTHER PLAYS

Washington vs PHILADELPHIA - TNF - PHI enters this NFC East clash having won 5 of the L/6 meetings SU but are just 2-3-1 ATS. The Eagles have now won 5 straight games and last week beat up on the Cowboys 34-6, holding them to 146 total yds. Here they face a more dynamic WAS offense led by QB Daniels & they are off a close 28-27 loss vs PIT. WAS does allow 142 rush ypg (4.8) and PHI avg's 214 rush ypg (5.2) over the L/4 games. PHI has been phenomenal on defense, allowing just 190 ypg/12 ppg over the L/4 games but the WAS offense puts up 35 ypg more than their foes allow (#6 NFL). **Call the office on Thur after Noon for the Marquee Winner!**

NEW ORLEANS by 3 over Cleveland - CLE is back in action off their bye and two weeks ago were beat 27-10 at home vs LAC where backup QB Winston threw 3 int's and CLE only ran for 79 yds (3.3). NOLA was playing uner interim HC Rizzi and benefitted from 3 ATL missed FG's in a 20-17 win. The Browns offense showed life vs BAL but overall are getting held to 69 ypg under what their foes allow (#31 NFL). NE's offense is still only averaging 271 ypg/16 ppg on the season and the Rams defense is allowing just 314 ypg in their L/4 games incl allowing just 90 rush ypg (3.4) as their DLine is becoming better by the week and they have 15 sacks the L/4 games. LAR does struggle to run the ball (90, 3.5 the L/4 games) but QB Staffordis hitting 65% and they have WR's Kupp and Nacua back in the offense. Though they are traveling out East off short rest, this Rams team is looking to regroup and won't take Rookie QB Maye or the Pats lightly.

MIAMI by 10 over Las Vegas - MIA is back home after 2 straight road games, and they are off short rest after playing on MON night, where they won 23-15 despite only putting up 238 yds. The Raiders are off a bye, but are in rough shape, as they have lost 5 straight games (avg'g 273 ypg/18 ppg) and overall are just 2-7 & their avg loss is by 13 pts. MIA QB Tua is hitting 77% in his 3 games back from inj and the Raiders pass D allows 68% completions. The Dolphins need to stack wins if they have any hope of turning their season around, and with Las Vegas traveling cross country for a 1pm kick, we feel like the Dolphins will ride the momentum of their win last week and have their way with a struggling Raiders team that is last in the NFL with a -14 TO margin.

DETROIT by 17 over Jacksonville - The Lions are the NFL's hottest team, sitting at 8-1 off a comeback win in HOU where they overcame a 5 int's by QB Goff and a 23-7 deficit to win 26-23 as the defense only allowed 248 yds and forced a pair of TO's themselves. JAX was w/o QB Lawrence and the offense was held to 143 yds and 7 pts but were still in this game as they forced 3 int's. JAX's defense could be in for a long day as they are last in the NFL, allowing foes to gain 74 ypg above their avg and their pass D allows 70% completions and 261 pass ypg. JAX is also -110 ypg on the road. The Lions offense is one of the best in the league and QB Goff hits 72% plus the 1-2 punch at RB of Montgomery and Gibbs is potent. JAX is allowing 192 rush ypg (4.5) the L/3 weeks. This is a large spread, but at home vs TEN a few weeks ago were -11' and won 52-14. DET will keep pouring it on if they get ahead and we see think winning by over 2 td's.

Minnesota by 3 over TENNESSEE - Minn moved to 7-2 on the season, and despite holding a 402-143 yd edge over JAX a week ago, they had to hold on and win 12-7, as QB Darnold threw 3 int's incl one in the end zone. TEN is just 2-7 on the season, but did stay competitive with LAC early last week and were only -20 yds. TEN's offense overall avg's just 296 ypg/17 ppg and they went back to QB Lewis last week. MIN's defense has held their L/4 foes to an avg of 287 ypg and they have 10 sks the L/4 games. TEN does have a strong defense as they hold foes to 54 ypg under their avg (#3 NFL) and allow just 274 ypg. Five of MIN's 7 wins are by single digits and at home we feel like the Titans defense can keep them in this game & the Vikings will squeak out another win.

SAN FRANCISCO by 10 over Seattle - Since 2022 SF is 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS vs their NFC West rivals. In their earlier meeting this season SF held a 483-358 yd edge in a 36-24 win where SF ran for a season-high 228 yds (6.9). SF got back RB McCaffrey last week and QB Purdy threw for a season-best 353 yds and a 2-0 ratio. SEA's pass D does allow 72% and 204 ypg ont the road and overall SEA's defense does allow foes to gain 24 ypg above their season avg (#27 NFL). SEA's

ATL is off a loss at NOLA where they were +103 yds but kicker Koo missed 3 fg's and the Falcons lost 20-17. DEN QB Nix has a 10-2 ratio since Week 3 of the season and overall is hitting 64% and the Falcons secondary allows 70% completions and 223 ypg on the season. DEN has 35 sacks on the season and allow just 104 rush ypg (3.9), plus they have a good secondary that can limit ATL's WR's. DEN does have the advantage of the altitude and ATL is traveling there & not used to it. DEN is now 7-3 ATS on the season & at home laying less than a fg we like the Broncos at home by a td.

NY JETS by 1 over Indianapolis - The NYJ were back to their losing ways last week after a win the previous Thur night had fans hopeful the Jets would turn things around. Nope. NYJ is avg'g just 299 ypg/18 ppg this season and their defense was hit for 406 yards and 31 pts last week as they allowed ARZ QB Murray to hit 22-24 passes. IND has now dropped 3 in row and the move back to QB Flacco has not paid off. Colts are avg'g just 294 ypg/17 ppg the L/4 games and are only rushing the ball for 121 ypg (4.7). NYJ cannot run the ball with any consistency (87, 4.0) and the Colts have only allowed 138 (4.1) the L/4 games. While we feel like the Jets can grab a close win at home, Indy is 5-2 ATS as a dog this season & we have ZERO confidence in the Jets laying over a fg.

Cincinnati vs LA CHARGERS - SNF - Game was flexed to Sun Night. LAC is riding a 3 game win streak, with all 3 wins coming by 10+ points. LAC allows a league-best 13.1 ppg and their pass rush has 18 sacks the last 3 games! Cincy put up 470 yards on BAL a week ago incl 428 pass yds for QB Burrow & WR Chase had 264 yds & 3 td! LAC QB Herbert is quietly having a good season as he is hitting 66% with an 11-1 ratio and young WR's Johnston & McConkey are stepping up. Cincy has gotten improvements on DEF, allowing just 335 ypg the L/4 games, but struggle at times to generate pressure. **Call the office on Sun after 11am EST for the Marquee Winner!**

Houston vs DALLAS - MNF - This is not the marquee matchup the NFL had hoped for at the beginning of the season.
