4★ COLORADO ST over Nevada - LY's outright win by CSU snapped a 4 game ATS losing streak to Nev. CSU kept their chances at a bowl alive with a 22-19 win vs SDSU (+154 ypg) while Nev lost to Utah St 41-24. CSU's run game is only avg'g 84 ypg (3.1) but passing shouldn't be a problem for CSU (312, 63%) vs a Nev pass D we have rated #127 (67%, 20-8). CSU is +51 ypg at home TY while Nev is -162 ypg on the road. Nev's only avg'g 305 ypg/19 ppg vs MW foes and CSU has allowed just 348 ypg the L/4 gms plus have a big ST edge (#42/#102). CSU still has something to play for while Nev does not and aren't playing with revenge on their mind vs their old coach like they were LY so we like the Rams at home here by over 3 td's!

FORECAST: COLORADO ST by 23

3★ IOWA over Illinois - These B10 West foes have played every yr s/'14 with the home team being 5-4 SU but just 1-8 ATS. The Hawkeyes have covered 5 of L/7 in series and the home team hasn't covered in L/5. LY the only scoring was on FGs, Illinois (-3') pulling out the win 9-6. Iowa is coming in with the #3 def, allowing 281 ypg. LW (-1') vs Rutgers, Iowa pitched a shutout 22-0, with their offense putting up a ssn high 402 yds. Illinois is just 2-8 ATS on the year, LW (-4') vs Indy backup QB Paddock had a great game throwing for 507 yds to pull off the OT win 48-45. With a win here Iowa will clinch the B10 West and all but 1 of the Hawkeyes wins have come by over 6 points and they are only laying 3'!

FORECAST: IOWA by 13

3★ Kansas St over KANSAS - 121st meeting of the Sunflower Showdown. KSt has won 14 straight vs KU and have covered 11 of those 14 mtgs incl the L/4. KU is off a 16-13 home loss to TT where QB Bean left (head inj) and could miss here, which likely means true frosh Cole Ballard will start unless orig starting QB Daniels comes back. KSt's D is holding tms to 57 ypg under their avg (#22) and while KU's offense puts up 448 ypg/37 ppg at home and are avg'g 260 rush ypg (6.1) KSt will focus in on RB's Neal and Hishaw if both Bean & Daniels don't play. KU is on a 9-2-1 ATS run at home but KSt is +119 ypg/+28 ppg the L/4 gms while KU is just +2 ypg/+1 ypg. We have used a 5★ GOY involving KSt in the past and think the Wildcats will continue their dominance in this rivalry and this could be in the mix for this season's GOY!

FORECAST: KANSAS ST by 17

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Syracuse (+) over GEORGIA TECH - GT is 3-1 in this series but they haven't met since '20 when Cuse won 37-20. Cuse primarily used a wildcat offense with TE Dan Villari (former W/O QB at Mich) who ran for 154 yds. The Orange ran for 382 yds and beat Pitt 28-13 (+3). GT is off a 42-21 loss where they were outgained 465-254 by Clemson. The Jackets gave up 260 rush (5.3) and are now #132 in the FBS in rush D allowing 224 (5.3). GT is 0-5 ATS as a favorite under HC Key and we favor Cuse's new strategy against a porous run D so we will call for the Orange to pull the upset.

FORECAST: Syracuse by 3

2★ SAN JOSE ST over San Diego St - SJSt is just 1-9 SU/3-7 ATS vs SDSU. The Spartans won vs Fresno 42-18 LW where we won a 4★ LP play and 3★ PS play on SJSt. SDSU is just won 3-7 SU and cannot make a bowl. SJSt is avg'g 457 ypg/43 ppg during their 4 game win streak while SDSU is allowing 465 ypg on the road and are -164 ypg on the road. SJSt's defense meanwhile is holding tms to 290 ypg/16 ppg the L/4 gms and the Aztecs are putting up just 318 ypg in conf play. The Aztecs HC Hoke did announce he is retiring at the end of the season, but over the L/4 gms SJSt is +167 ypg/+27 ppg while SDSU is -78 ypg/-3 ppg. The Spartans have covered 7 of their L/8 games and we think they win big here.

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 15th

MIAMI, OH by 14 over Buffalo - Will help decide the MAC East Title. RedHawks clinch with a win, while the Bulls with a win can keep not only their's but Ohio's & BG's hopes alive. Home team has won & covered L/6. LY Miami (+3) led 20-17 into 4Q but allowed GW to wd:/31 to lose 24-20. Bulls are off a 20-10 loss to Ohio as a 7 pt HD a team Miami beat the week prior 30-16 as a 7 pt AD. Against 5 common MAC foes Miami is +15 ppg/+48 ypg going 4-1 SU & ATS while Buffalo is -3 ppg/+28 ypg going 2-3 SU & ATS. Look for the Redhawks to lock up their trip to Detroit here.

OHIO by 10 over Central Michigan - Ohio must win out to keep their slim MAC East Title hopes alive (need Mia to lose L/2). CM needs a win either here or vs Toledo next wk to become bowl elig. While CM has won & covered 6 straight over Ohio that is s/'13. Last me in '21 CM won 30-27 but failed to cover as a 5' pt AF. Against 3 common MAC foes Ohio is 2-1 SU/1-2 ATS (all as Fav) being +1 ppg/-5 ypg. CM is 1-2 SU & ATS (2 as dog) being -9 ppg/-31 ypg. CM however is 0-3 SU & ATS in conf road gms incl being upset twice. We will lean with the Bobcats here.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 16th

Boston College vs PITTSBURGH - BC won the last 2 mtgs back in '19 & '20. Pitt still has questions at QB after Veilleux (51%, 7-8) threw a back-breaking pick-6 LW in their loss to Cuse and was benched late. Pitt is -98 ypg in ACC play while BC is -14 though Pitt has ply'd the tougher sked (#23 vs #70). The Eagles have won their last 3 games outright as away dogs. BC is +46 ypg on the road while Pitt is -27 ypg at home. Pitt does have a 17 point win over #11 Louisville at home this year. Call 1-800-654-3448 to get our Thurs Night Marquee for \$12.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 17th

UTSA by 15 over Usf - First mtg. UTSA is 6-0/5-1 ATS vs AAC foes this year, winning by 18 ppg (+81 ypg) and the Roadrunners are 16-8 ATS vs conference foes since '21. Usf beat Temple 27-23 (-7) and needs one more win to get bowl eligible. The Bulls have given up 39 sacks and face UTSA's LB Trey Moore who leads the AAC with 14 sacks. Their Bulls did only lose by 9 at Memphis two weeks ago but they were down 17 prior to a garbage time td. The winner of UTSA's game vs Tulane next week will earn a trip to the AAC Title game and UTSA has played poorly before big games in Traylor's tenure so we don't feel comfortable laying nearly 3 td's here.

WASHINGTON ST by 3 over Colorado - A pair of teams heading in the wrong direction meet here as the Buffs (4th consec loss LW vs Ariz, Cats GW 24-yd FG as time expired) journey to Pullman to take on a Cougs squad that's dropped 6 in a row (SU & ATS) following a 3 pt defeat LW in Cal where the Bears got a pair of Def TD's. WSU has picked up 3 straight commanding wins over CU (18 pt avg cover) including a 41-10 (-12') home victory in their most recent contest back in '19 (Cougs 497-320 yd edge). While both teams need to win here to keep their slim bowl hopes alive, it's worth mentioning that WSU has failed to cover all 3 as a HF TY. With the Buffs covering each of their past 4, we're cutting off our lean at just a FG for the Cougs in this one.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 18th

JAMES MADISON by 14 over Appalachian St - 18th meeting, but just 2nd as SBC foes. LY App St led 28-10 HT but JMU outscored App St 22-0 in the 2H and pulled the upset. JMU is now 10-0 this ssn while App St clinched a bowl LW with a 42-14 win at GSt. App St has the #126 pass D and JMU QB McCcloud is hitting 70% (26-7). App St also allows 194 rush ypg (5.0) in SBC play. App St ran for 254 yds (6.5) LW but here face a JMU run D allowing just 60 ypg (2.0) in conf play. JMU also has 42 sks on the season & hold tms to 52 ypg under their avg (#29). JMU has the huge edge on defense (#30 vs #95) but App St is on a 3 gm win streak and Game Day is on hand so we will cut off our lean on JMU at 2 td's.

Coastal Carolina by 7 over ARMY - Only prior meeting was LY, which Coastal won 38-28 (+93 yds). CC is now on a 5-0 SU/ATS win streak as QB Vasko started again LW (63%, 2-0) while Army has won their L/2 gms despite being outgained in both (+8 TO's!). While Army is avg'g 194 rush ypg (4.2) Coastal's run D has allowed just 142 ypg (4.2) the L/4 games. In their L/4 games vs FBS foes Army is -142 ypg/-17 ppg and are allowing 202 rush ypg (5.5) and Coastal is +85 ypg/+13 ppg the L/4 games and are avg'g 199 rush ypg (4.6) the L/4 games. Coastal has the edge on offense (#67/#129) and ST's (#61/#98) and played the tougher sked (#88/#111). While this game falls in between 2 SBC gms for Coastal, they are rolling right now and we like them by a td.

Duke by 1 over VIRGINIA - We have fond memories of this game from when we used it as our first two 5★ Sept GOM's back in '84 & '85 with Virginia winning both. Duke ended an 0-7 SU run vs Virginia LY when they won 38-17 (-2). The home team is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series. Duke has really missed Riley Leonard but they did put up 45 points and true frosh QB Loftis threw 3 td's vs North Carolina LW. Virginia was w/o QB Tony Musкет LW but true frosh Anthony Colandrea threw for 314 yds and the 'Hoos actually led L'ville 21-14 3Q. They also put up 434 yds, 149 yds more than UL was giving up on avg. The loss was Virginia's 5th by 7 points or less. Duke is -107 ypg in ACC play while Virginia is only -20. Duke's huge ST's edge (#21 vs #116) could be the difference but our lean is with the underdog.

WEST VIRGINIA by 17 over Cincinnati - Former Big East foes meet for the 1st time since 2011. Prior to LW WVU had been putting up 510 ypg the L/4 gms but were held to 330 LW vs OU while Cincy won their 1st B12 gm at Hou 24-14. WVU is rushing for 256 ypg (5.5) the L/4 gms and now face a Cincy rush D that has allowed 227 ypg (6.9) the L/3 gms. While Cincy's offense is avg'g 216 rush ypg (5.0) in B12 play, WVU's run D is allowing just 128 rush ypg (4.1) in home games. UC QB Jones is hitting 62% vs FBS foes & has a 10-10 ratio and here faces the #56 pass D and they are allowing just 179 pass ypg (50%) at home. Cincy is just 2-4-1 ATS in B12 gms & while WVU lost bad LW they are 4-1 ATS at home TY and we will roll with WVU by over 2 td's.

INDIANA by 7 over Michigan St - MSU have more wins (50) over Indiana than any other foe. Home team is just 1-4 SU & 0-5 ATS s/'16 but Indy has won 2 of the L/3. LY Indy (+10') down 24-7 at half came from behind to win 39-31 in 2OT, outgained by 252 yds & MSU missed GW 22yd FG. LW Indy (+4') fell in OT to Illinois 48-45 (3rd straight cover), QB Sorsby 22-33-289-3-1 & -211 net yards. MSU (+31') fell to OSU 38-3, def gave up 530 yds & had a ssn low 88 pass yds. Both teams are not bowl eligible but are playing for the Old Brass Spitoon, we lean with Indiana, who is 6-1 as a B10 HF s/'17, to get the home win here.

Georgia by 6 over TENNESSEE - Tenn has lost 6 straight in this series, with last year's 27-13 defeat being the closest they've come to upsetting UGA who has covered 6 of the L/7 mtgs. TE Bowers made a surprise return LW and UGA ran through Ole Miss 52-17 (-10') w/a 611-352 yd edge. Tenn got smoked at Mizzou LW 36-7. UGA is now 28-15 ATS vs ranked foes but Tenn is 9-1 ATS, +31 ppg and +204 ypg at home the last two years. The Vols are getting '10' points and they did lead Bama 20-7 at half on the road and only lost at UGA by 14 last year so our lean is with the Vols.

Michigan by 28 over MARYLAND - Mich is 7-1 SU & 6-2 ATS (only loss 1st B10 mtg '14) vs MD in B10 mtgs. In those 6 covers they have had an MOV of 33.7. LTH (-15') Mich with OSU on deck, won easily 59-18, putting up 503 yds off. Mich (-4') is coming off a big win at PSU 24-15 LW, despite only having 60 yds pass but did hold them to a ssn low 238 yds. MD (-2) vs NEB kicked a GW FG as time expired to get their 6th win and held them to 86 yds below their ssn avg. Mich has covered 5 of L/6 & MD has failed to cover 4 of L/5, the signs point to Mich winning big here!

MIAMI, FL by 6 over Louisville - UM has won the L/2 mtgs by 13 & 25 points. UL had their worst defensive performance since week 1 last week when they gave up 434 yds and only beat UVA 31-24. The Cards lost their last road game at Pitt by 17 and only won by 3 at NCSt this year. UM is 5-1 SU at home (+140 ypg) with wins over Clemson & A&M. The 'Canes D is only allowing 322 ypg and they allow just 86 rush ypg. The 'Canes are off B2B losses but showed life in a 7 pt loss at FSU. Miami is primed to pull the upset against a UL team that is just 7-16-1 ATS on the road since '18.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 3 over Kentucky - SC is just 2-7 ATS in this series but they did pull the upset last year 24-14 (-6'). SC took care of business LW vs Vandy in a 47-6 (-13') and finished w/a 487-234 yd edge. The Gamecocks need to win out to be bowl eligible. KY has failed to cover 4 of their L/5 after getting crushed at home vs Bama 49-21 (+11). The 'Cats have also been held under 300 yds in 4 of their L/5. SC is allowing 414 ypg but in their L/4 they've only allowed 357. Against 6 common foes KY is -1 ppg & -52 ypg while SC is -1 ppg & -48 ypg. These teams seem pretty even so we will take the home underdog. We won this year's Sept 5★ on SC so could we go back to the Gamecocks for our GOY?

VIRGINIA TECH by 8 over NC State - Virginia Tech has covered the last 6 meetings including last year when they were +13' but only lost 22-21. NC State pulled B2B upsets against Clemson & Miami then QB Morris surprised HC Doeren by deciding to redshirt. The Wolfpack rallied around Brennan Armstrong and they had a 265-45 yd edge in the 1H of a 26-6 (-1') win. Virginia Tech rebounded strong from a loss LW in their 48-22 win at BC. The Hokies still need a win to get bowl eligible and they've won all 3 ACC home games by at least 17 pts (+248) and they've won their L/6 home finales so we will ride with Enter Sandman.

PENN ST by 13 over Rutgers - Since joining the B10 in '14, PSU has won each matchup. PSU has been ranked 4 times in this series s/'17 & only have covered once (LY). Rutgers has had 0 td's in their L/4 at PSU. Against non-ranked foes this year PSU is 6-0 SU/ATS while Rutgers has played close to the line pushing in both their ranked matchups. PSU (+4') fell short to Mich 24-15, gave up a ssn high 227 on the ground. Rutgers (+1') got held to a ssn low 127 yds at Iowa falling 22-0. PSU has put up just 306 ypg in their L/4 and OC Yurcich was fired after the loss. HC Franklin is just 10-24 ATS off a SU loss including only beating Indiana 9 off their loss to OSU and we think Rutgers defense keeps them in this game as HC Schiano is 10-4-1 ATS as an AD since 2020.

CLEMSON by 3 over North Carolina - The Tar Heels are an underdog for the first time this year and North Carolina was 3-0 as an away dog LY. Clemson has won the L/5 mtgs including in last year's ACC Title game 39-10 (-7'). They've rebounded from their 4-4 start by beating ND did what North Carolina couldn't do, beating Georgia Tech 42-21 w/a 465-254 yd edge. NC only beat Duke by 2 in OT but had a +158 yd edge and settled for 5 fg's. The Tigers are 4-10 ATS since last year when they don't have the turnover edge and they face a Tar Heels team who has forced 19 turnovers (#1 in ACC) and is +11 TO's (#3 in FBS). Clemson has played the tougher sked (#29 vs #68) but we think Drake Maye keeps North Carolina within a fg.

OHIO ST by 21 over Minnesota - Ohio St leads series 46-7 winning 40 of L/43 but are just 6-5-1 ATS L/12. Minn has covered their last two in Columbus & was up at HT 14-10 LTH in '21 but lost 45-31. Minn (PK) LW gave up their most yds in a game s/'20 at Purdue (604) falling 49-30. OSU has gotten healthy at the right time easily beating MSU (-31') 38-3, WR Harrison 3 all purp TDs in 1st half. The Gophers are 9-5-1 as an AD s/'20 while OSU is 1-8 ATS with Mich on deck. We expect the Buckeyes to win here but with "The Game" on deck we lean with Minn to get the cover.

Tulane by 4 over FLORIDA ATLANTIC - FAU won only prior mtg in '13. Tulane is +51 ypg vs the AAC and was outgained by 120 yds vs Tulsa LW but won 24-22. FAU is -36 vs the AAC although FAU is +4 ppg vs the AAC while FAU is only +6 ppg. FAU just lost at home to EC and was held to 172 yds in a 15 pt loss. The Green Wave have a huge game against UTSA on deck and their closest win in conference play is by just 12 points. HC Herman is 19-5 ATS as a dog in his career and Tulane has failed to cover their last 5 as Double-Digit Chalk.

NAVY by 3 over East Carolina - Navy is 7-0 ATS in this series and have won 8 of the last 10 meetings SU. EC is -65 ypg against our #67 sked while Navy is -60 ypg against our #120 sked. EC did upset FAU 22-7 (+7) LW and held the Owls to just 172 yds. Navy had a misleading final LW as they only led UAB 10-6 (+2) 4Q but won by 25. The Pirates are allowing just 113 rush ypg (3.2). HC Houston is 14-6 as an away dog and with the Pirates getting over a fg we will lean with the underdog.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 6 over Old Dominion - 4th all-time meeting. GS already reached 6 wins while ODU needs to win out for a bowl. GSthrn comes in avg'g 307 pass ypg (65%) and here faces the #117 pass D that is allowing 250 ypg (68%) in SBC play. However in Sun Belt play GSthrn is -25 ypg while ODU is just -28 ypg. ODU is putting up a solid 389 ypg in SBC play will take on a GSthrn D allowing 430 ypg/35 ppg in conf play and have the #120 defense. ODU has also taken on the tougher sked (#78/#105) and have had every SBC game TY decided by 7 pts or less, so we like ODU to hang around & keep it close.

NORTHWESTERN by 7 over Purdue - The Wildcats are 8-4 SU/ATS vs the Boilermakers s/ '08. NW (+17) LY was trailing 14-3 at half & got close in the 4th fallin' 14-9. LW NW (+12) pulled off an upset win at Wisky, QB Bryant back from inj' was solid going 18-26-195-2-0. Cats have 3 of their L/4. Purdue (PK) used their ground game to win at home vs Minn 49-30, rushed for 353 yds which is the most they've had in a game s/'12. The home team is 1-9 ATS in this series but NW has wins vs Minn & Maryland at home & we will take them to become bowl eligible!

BALL ST by 14 over Kent St - Both will be sitting home for bowls. Kent St 0-9 SU & 1-7-1 ATS vs FBS foes. In their only close FBS gm they blew a 27-10 4Q lead vs Akron losing 31-27 as a 4 pt AD. Cardinals have pulled 2 upsets in their L/3 & have covered 4 straight. Both lost to their 2 common foes (BG & EM) but Flashes (0-2 ATS) were out scored by a comb 77-33 (22 ppg) while Cardinals (1-1) lost by a combined 48-31 (8.5 ppg). We will go with the home team by 2 td's.

CHARLOTTE by 3 over Rice - Former CUSA foes meet in AAC play. Rice must win for a bowl but are -89 ypg in AAC play while CLT is +21. QB Daniels was out w/a concussion LW and Rice lost 34-14 (+13). The Owls only put up 229 yds and had a 75 yd td drive in garbage time. Rice is beat up after a rough 3 game stretch where they played the top 3 AAC teams in a row. CLT was +10' and led Memphis 38-28 4Q but lost in OT. The Owls are just 5-12 ATS as a favorite since '17 and even if Daniels returns this week we like the 49ers chances to pull the upset.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 17 over Southern Miss - Will be the 31st meeting. Last met here in '19 where Miss St (-16) won 38-15. Miss St needs to win out to reach a bowl while SMiss has won 2 straight, but have just 3 wins on the season. SMiss has seen their run game get going the L/3 gms (245, 5.0) led by RB Gore (970, 4.9) and while Miss St has a solid run D (144, 4.0) they allowed 246 rush (5.5) LW to A&M. Miss St is also avg'g just 251 ypg the L/4 gms but that is vs 4 SEC foes as they avg 424 ypg in 3 non-conf gms. This is Greg Knox's 3rd stint as an Interim HC including in '17 when he led Miss St to a win over Lamar Jackson in their bowl. Miss St has the huge sked edge (#15/#83) and defense edge (#55/#113) and the the Bulldogs will get a feel-good win here by over 2 td's.

LIBERTY by 35 over UMass - These two non-conf foes have met each year since '18 with Liberty winning the L/4 by 38 ypg. Last year was the closest of the 4 mtgs with UMass scoring late to "only" lose 42-24 (+24). The Minutemen are fresh off a bye while Lib beat Old Dominion 38-10 (-13). The Flames are +149 ypg while UMass is -57 ypg. Liberty has a great shot to go 13-0 and is in the mix for the NY6 Bowl slot but needs blowout wins thanks to their weak schedule.

Utah by 6 over ARIZONA - We won our very first two 5★ College GOY's using Arizona back in '82 & '83. The Utes are back on the road for a 2nd consec wk following a 7 pt loss in Seattle where they actually led 28-24 at HT (UW 457-382 yd edge). The Cats meanwhile have won 4 in a row after a 34-31 victory in Boulder where they got a 24-yd FG w/00 left (Cats 421-339 yd edge). Utah has dominated recent meetings with 6 straight wins (5-1 ATS) that includes a 45-20 (-17) win LY in SLC where they finished with 27-14 FD and 457-387 yd edges. The HT has covered 5 of the L/7 in this matchup while the Wildcats are a perfect 5-0 ATS (4-1 SU) in Tucson with an avg cover of 9 ppg. If still a dog by the end of the wk, keep in mind that the Utes are an outstanding 15-3 ATS as an AD since '14 and 5-1 ATS off a SU loss while getting points for just the 3rd time in this series dating back to 2000.

Oregon by 28 over ARIZONA ST - The Ducks continue to dominate since their narrow loss to the Huskies as LW's 9 pt home win over USC was their 4th consec victory (QB Nix 412 pass yds & 4 TD). The Sun Devils meanwhile went into the Rose Bowl and picked up a shocking 17-7 (+17) outright upset despite being w/o 14 players incl 5 OL! After winning 10 straight from '05-'16, the Ducks have surprisingly dropped 2 of the past 3 (both as road chalk) against ASU including a 31-28 (-14) loss in '19 where the hometown Sun Devils finished with a 535-458 yd edge (UO -2 TO's). Oregon has covered 8 of their 10 contests on the ssn and arguably look like a true candidate to reach the FBS playoff. While ASU HC Dillingham coached at Oregon LY, the Ducks are in a 7-2 ATS run as an AF and we see them getting a solid victory in this one.

Oklahoma by 31 over BYU - 3rd meeting, first since '09. OU is off a 59-20 win vs WVU (+314 yds) where QB Gabriel has 8 total td's (5 pass, 3 rush) while BYU was blown out 45-13 at home vs ISU (-125 yds, -3 TO). While OU is allowing 415 ypg in B12 play, BYU comes in avg'g just 295 ypg in

B12 play and are getting held to 80 ypg less than their foes allow (#126). BYU is also -160 ypg in B12 play while OU is +78 and the Sooners are +64 ypg on the road. BYU's D is also all'g 438 ypg the L/4 gms and OU's offense avg's 493 ypg in B12 play. OU has a big edge on offense (#3/#97) and defense (#27/#107) and with BYU being -147 ypg/-20 ppg the L/4 plus the Sooners asserting themselves last week on offense, we like OU to win here by over 4 td's.

WYOMING by 17 over Hawaii - As MW foes UH has covered 5 of the 7 meetings. WY is off a 34-14 loss at UNLV while UH has won their L/2 MW gms incl a 27-13 upset of AF LW. While WY has struggled some vs the run in MW play (176, 4.8) UH can't run the ball (70, 2.9) and WY has the #62 pass D and are allowing just 203 pass ypg in MW play. UH's run D (206, 4.7 vs MW) takes on WY's RB Waylee (715, 5.9). UH has the #100 pass D and WY QB Peasley has a 15-5 ratio. Hawaii got an upset win LW but that was at home where they were actually outgained, but were +4 TO's and here have to deal with the altitude and potential bad weather. Give us the Cowboys by over 2 td's as they are on a 10-4 ATS run as a HF in MW play since 2016 & UH is -56 ypg/-17 ppg on the road TY.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 3 over Utep - MT is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series and won 24-13 (+2). Both teams are staying home for bowl season but MT did beat FIU 40-6 (-10') LW. UTEP is fresh off a bye. The Miners are actually +37 ypg vs CUSA foes while MT is +1 ypg vs CUSA foes. UTEP has a banged up OLine but they only lost by 8 to WKU two weeks ago and they've won their L/2 road games so we are comfortable siding with the Miners as 7' pt dogs.

JACKSONVILLE ST by 7 over Louisiana Tech - First mtg. JSU has won 10 of their last 11 on Senior Day. The Gamecocks are fresh off a bye and just two weeks ago were driving for a go-ahead score at South Carolina but QB Webb threw a pick-6. The Gamecocks have covered 6 of their last 7 gms. This is LT's ssn finale and they've lost their last 5. Three of those losses came by 8 points or less but they lost by 26 at Liberty then were upset LW 42-27 (-7) vs new FBS member Sam Houston despite putting up a ssn high 501 yds. LT will not want to be the only CUSA school to get swept by both SH and JSU and they are +28 ypg vs CUSA while JSU is -20.

OREGON ST by 3 over Washington - The onslaught of tough P12 contests continue for the undefeated Huskies in this one following a 10 pt win at USC and a narrow 7 pt home victory LW against the Utes where QB Penix threw for 332 yds and 2 TD's. The Beavers meanwhile continued their home dominance a week ago against the Cardinal as they put up a ssn-best 277 rush yds (6.9) in the 45 pt victory. The Huskies are on a 10-1 SU run in this series although they've now failed to cover 3 straight against the Beavers including a 27-24 (+2) road defeat in '21. While Reser Stadium will be electric for this key P12 battle, UW hasn't lost an outright road contest since the midway point of LY but Oregon St is on a 17-1 SU/ATS run at home & UW has won 5 of their L/6 gms by single digits and are playing with unbeaten pressure, we think this is the week they finally fall.

FRESNO ST vs 14 over New Mexico - As MW foes Fresno is 7-1 SU/ATS vs NMex. Fresno lost LW at SJSU 42-18 (3★ Power Sweep & LP winner on SJSU!) while NMex lost their 7th game and cant make a bowl. Fresno does have the edge on D (#79/#128) and ST (#34/#111). Against MW foes Fresno is 4-2 SU but are actually -39 ypg while NMex at 1-5 SU and are just -43 ypg. Fresno is allowing 485 ypg the L/4 gms and NMex is avg'g 387 ypg in MW play. Fresno is also just 1-5 ATS in MW play and are just +1 ppg in MW play and despite not having a bowl to play for anymore we see NMex being able to cover this large spread.

USC by 9 over UCLA - The battle for the Victory Bell has seen USC win 6 of the L/8 including 5 covers. LY with a trip to the P12 Title game on the line, USC (-2) went into the Rose Bowl and escaped with a 48-45 victory despite trailing 14-0 in the 2Q (Trojans 649-513 yd edge). USC does return home following their 4th loss in 5 tries LW in Eugene (Ducks 552-379 yd edge). The Bruins meanwhile suffered a shocking 17-7 home loss (-17) against ASU despite a 300-250 yd edge. The Trojans have failed to cover 7 of their L/8 coming in including 3 in a row at the Coliseum. UCLA hasn't been much better away from home however as they've failed to cover 4 of the past 5 P12 AG's.

California by 7 over STANFORD - This marks the 117th version of the "Big Game" with the Cardinal owning a 60-46-10 all-time edge. After losing 9 straight from '10-'18, the Bears have picked up victories in 3 of the L/4 including a 27-20 (-5) win LY in Berkeley where they got a key 37 yd FR TD trailing midway through the 4Q. The Cardinal had a rough performance LW in Corvallis with the Beavers having 29-18 FD and 598-324 yd edges in the 45 pt win (SU -4 TO's). Cal meanwhile grabbed a 42-39 home win against WSU helping to easily cash our 5★ Totals GOY on Over 59'!. While the Bears have failed to cover 5 of their L/7 as an AF heading in, we expect them to grab a victory here (Cal can still make a bowl) as the Cardinal haven't won on "The Farm" since the middle of LY (0-7 SU/2-5 ATS, 19 pt avg defeat).

LSU by 38 over Georgia St - First mtg. Georgia St has allowed over 500 yards in B2B games which doesn't bode well when facing the Nation's #1 offense that avg 560 ypg! Jaylen Daniels became the first FBS QB ever to throw for over 350 yards and rush for over 200 (234 on just 12 carries!!!). LSU beat FL 52-35 (-15) while Georgia St has lost their last 3 by 17, 28 & 28. LSU's D is a concern, allowing 416 ypg. The Panthers upset Tenn in '19, led Auburn in the 4Q in '21 and led SCar in the 3Q last year. With A&M on deck LSU will give up some points but we don't see Georgia St getting many stops and Daniels should have a monster day here!

Over 41 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 61% winners over 41 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years. Here is This week's Underdog Play:

IOWA ST +8 over Texas

IOWA ST (+) over Texas - Texas is just 1-3 SU/ATS in the L/4 mtgs and the previous 8 meetings have all gone 'Under' the total with an avg of 36 ppg in those gms. ISU is off a 45-13 win at BYU while Tex hung on to beat TCU 29-26. Texas is rushing for 198 ypg (5.0) in B12 play but just lost RB Brooks (1138, 6.1, 10 td) for the season (ACL) and ISU has held their L/4 foes to just 111 rush ypg (3.3). ISU is holding tms to 56 ypg under their avg (#24) and Texas is holding tms to 64 ypg under their avg (#23). The L/4 gms ISU is +85 ypg/+14 ppg while Texas is +60 ypg/+11 ppg. This was a 3-pt game LY and 3 of the L/4 wins for Texas have been 1 score gms and we see ISU keeping it close again vs Texas as HC Campbell is 11-5-1 ATS as a home dog here and could even pull the outright upset!

MISSISSIPPI by 38 over ULM - Ole Miss has won all 4 prevois mtgs and they last met in 2018 with Ole Miss winning 70-21. Miss is off a 52-17 loss at UGA where they all'd 611 yds but should be able to move the ball better here vs a ULM D giving up 47 ypg more than their foes avg (#122). ULM is also putting up just 336 ypg and are -104 ypg on the ssn while Miss is +176 ypg in non-conf play. While this is a large spread & Miss has the Egg Bowl on deck, ULM has been outscored 162-20 in their L/3 gms vs Power 5 teams (A&M, Texas, Bama) and Miss could take out some frustration this week on an inferior foe.

North Texas by 10 over TULSA - These two new AAC foes last met in '13. Both tms are staying home for bowl season coming in with 7 losses. NT was no match for SMU last Friday, losing 45-21, though it was only 17-14 at half. Tulsa started w/ QB Kirk Francis and he threw for 357 at Tulane as the Golden Hurricane held a 477-357 yd edge but lost 24-22 (+24). That was Tulsa's 5th straight loss, though the last two have been close. NT has lost four straight to the 4 teams still alive to win the AAC Title. The Mean Green have a big edge on offense (#16 vs #83) but Tulsa has the edge on D (#83 vs #133). We will back the better QB in Chandler Rogers (23-4 ratio) by over a td.

TROY by 21 over Louisiana - The home team is just 1-6-1 ATS in the L/8. LA needs 1 win in their L/2 games to reach a bowl while a win here for Troy would lock up the SBC West. LA is -57 ypg in SBC play while Troy is +116 ypg and are holding teams to 91 ypg under their avg (#9 FBS) and LA is only putting up 339 ypg the L/4 gms and are on their 3rd QB of the season. LA has all'd 200+ rush yds in 4 of the L/6 gms & here face Troy RB Vidal (1169, 5.7) who is #5 in the FBS in rushing. Troy has also faced the tougher sked (#90/#118) and have a massive edge on D (#20/#106) plus are +91 ypg/+22 ppg the L/4 gms and have covered 6 straight and are getting stronger as the season moves along.

Smu by 14 over MEMPHIS - The home team has won the last 4 mtgs, all decided by 6 pts or less. SMU has dominated AAC play, winning by 30 ppg and +212 ypg though none of their wins this year have come over teams with a winning record and their AAC opponents are a combined 8-28. Memphis only has one conference loss, by 10 at home vs Tulane. The Tigers 5 conference come over teams that are a combined 11-19 but they are only +6 ppg and -8 ypg vs AAC foes. SMU's D is holding foes to 291 ypg and 86 ypg below their avg (#12 in FBS). The winner of this game will likely get a trip to the AAC Title game. Memphis is a normally strong team at home but they are just 0-4-1 ATS there this year and SMU looks like the stronger team with a big edge on D.

UAB by 14 over Temple - First meeting. It's Sr Day at UAB. The Blazers struggled to defend Navy's option LW in a 31-6 (-2) loss. Temple has lost 6 of their last 7 and is getting outscored by 21 ppg and -154 ypg on the road. UAB is +2 ppg and +93 ypg at home which includes a 21 pt win over USF. Temple lost to that same USF team LW 27-23 (+7) and they were -62 yds and -3 TO's. It's hard to back the Owls on the road and they are just 3-11 as an AD while UAB is 19-8-2 as a HF s/17.

Oklahoma St by 14 over HOUSTON - 21st meeting, teams have not met since 2009 where Houston (+15) upset Okla St 45-35. Okla St has the big edge on offense (#40/#95) and QB Bowman is throwing for 264 ypg the L/4 gms and UH has the #108 pass D and are allowing 70% completions in B12 play. UH is allowing 188 rush ypg (4.4) in B12 play and here face RB Gordon (1249, 6.7, 12 td). Okla St is allowing 500 ypg the L/4 gms but UH's offense has put up just 302 ypg/16 ppg the L/4 gms and are -95 ypg/-14 ppg in B12 play. Okla St is off an embarrassing loss and we feel like there is value in this line, as they were traveling to UCF for the 1st time & were off an emotional game vs OU the week prior. Okla St will be re-focused with the B12 title game still in play and win here by 2 td's.

ARKANSAS by 28 over Fiu - Sam Pittman's days in Fayetteville are likely numbered after Ark's embarrassing 48-10 loss to Auburn LW. The Hogs allowed Auburn to put up a ssn high 517 yds including 354 rush yds. FIU is the only team with a shot at a bowl here but they've lost their last 2 by 25 to Jax St and they were crushed 40-6 LW at Middle Tenn. We have a hard time putting faith in either team but with Ark laying a big number we would rather side with the dog.

TCU by 20 over Baylor - TCU is on an 8-0 SU/5-3 ATS run vs Baylor. The Bears lost 59-25 LW at KSt while TCU only lost by 3 at Texas. The Bears have the #113 pass D and are facing a TCU offense avg'g 302 pass ypg in B12 play and QB Hoover threw for 302 and 2 td's vs a much better Texas pass D. Baylor is now -58 ypg in B12 play while TCU is +58 ypg. BU's offense is just putting up 362 ypg the L/4 gms. TCU has big edges on offense (#24/#65) and defense (#41/#78) and Baylor has nothing to play for with 7 losses while TCU needs to win these L/2 gms in order to reach a bowl so they will be motivated & we like the Horned Frogs by nearly 3 td's.

MISSOURI by 18 over Florida - Mizzou has only been favored in this series once, back in '17 when they won 45-16. The Tigers put up the most yds Tenn has allowed all season LW (530) in their 36-7 win (+2). RB Cody Schrader had 321 total yards (205 rush) and leads the SEC with 1,124 (5.7). FL's rush D has given up 220 (5.8) in their L/4 including 329 vs LSU LW and also allowed 329 at KY earlier this year. At 5-5, FL needs to pull an upset vs either Mizzou or FSU next week or they are staying home for bowl season. The Tigers are +90 ypg vs SEC foes and they would be 4-0 ATS at home vs P5 foes this year if it weren't for a late Pick-6 vs LSU. Against 6 common foes Mizzou is 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS, +11 ppg & +90 ypg while FL is 3-3 SU/ATS, -3 ppg & -50 ypg. Mizzou has the edge on offense & defense and they are at home so we will give them over a 2 td edge.

AUBURN by 16 over New Mexico St - Hugh Freeze's last game at Liberty was against New Mexico St when the Flames' players found out he was leaving and played flat in a 49-14 loss. Both tms are bowl eligible. Auburn is +25 ypg on the season and have won 3 straight, all by double-digits. NMSt clinched a spot in the CUSA Title game by beating WKU LW 38-29 (+4). QB Pavia has a 19-6 ratio. NMSt has lost to 3 SEC schools by an avg of 53-11 in the L/2Y but might put up a better fight considering they are on a 6 game winning streak. With the Iron Bowl on deck, and Auburn's 3-7 ATS record vs non-P5's in November we have a solid lean on the underdog.

TEXAS TECH by 3 over Ucf - First meeting. UCF is off a stunning 45-3 win at home vs Okla St where they were +315 yds and TT hung on to pull the upset at Kansas 16-13. While TT can move the ball through the air, UCF does have the #18 pass D (57%, 8-9). TT has a stout RB in Tahj Brooks (1170, 5.2) and while UCF went into LW's gm allowing 281 rush ypg (5.9) they held the nation's leading rusher to just 25 yds. TT did allow 207 rush (4.6) LW and UCF is rushing for 206 (5.3) in Big 12

WKU by 7 over Sam Houston - SH finally got their first CUSA win LW, beating LA Tech 42-27. They led 21-6 3Q but were only up 8 until a late Pick-6 sealed the victory. WKU still needs a win to get to a bowl. The Toppers led NMSt 14-0 1Q and finished with 437-361 yd & 26-20 FD edges but gave up a pick 6 and missed 2 fg's in a 38-29 loss. WKU is -11 ypg in CUSA play while SH is -42. SH is just 2-8 but their largest loss to a CUSA foe is by just 14 points and QB Shoemaker has an 11-4 ratio in CUSA play so we could see them sticking closer than expected with WKU.

NOTRE DAME by 31 over Wake Forest - WF must win out to avoid missing a bowl for the first time since '15. ND looks to avoid their 3rd loss to an ACC team this year. The Irish are 5-0 vs WF since '11. ND is fresh off a bye while WF was embarrassed by NCSt 26-6, getting outgained 265-45 in the 1H. ND beat that same NCSt team 45-24 on the road earlier this year. The Irish have big edges in all 3 phases and last year they won 44-0 over BC on Senior Day. We could see a similar result against an overmatched opponent and our last College 5★ GOY winner was on Notre Dame over an ACC foe (UVA in '21) so we could use the luck of the Irish again this year!

AIR FORCE by 3 over Unlv - AF has won 5 straight vs UNLV (3-2 ATS). AF has now dropped 2 straight after a loss at Hawaii LW and Air Force is -10 TO's the L/2 gms. Both teams sit at 5-1 SU in MW play and the winner will secure their spot in the MW title game. UNLV has outgained every MW TY and are +86 ypg while AF is also +86 ypg in MW play. UNLV's offense led by QB Maiava is putting up 449 ypg in MW play, but they could have trouble rushing vs an AF run D allowing 91 ypg (3.5) in cont play. UNLV however is giving up just 119 rush ypg (3.7) in MW play and AF's rush gm is putting up just 189 (3.9) the L/4 gms. UNLV does have to deal with the altitude & weather could play a role too, but we think the Rebels keep this close.

Texas St by 6 over ARKANSAS ST - TXSt has won 3 straight in this series (2-1 ATS). TXSt only had 81 pass yds LW but Ark St does have the #128 pass D (69%, 17-4) and were avg'g 273 pass ypg before LW's game. While TXSt is allowing just 357 ypg the L/4 gms Ark St is putting up 402 ypg the L/4 gms led by QB Raynor. TXSt does have the edge on offense (#54/#80) but the defense & ST's are nearly even. Ark St is +15 ypg at home while TXSt is -53 ypg on the road and we see Ark St keeping this game within a td.

SOUTH ALABAMA by 14 over Marshall - First meeting. Both teams are sitting at 5 wins so both are fully motivated with 2 weeks to play. Marshall broke their 0-5 SU/ATS losing skid LW with a 38-33 win vs GStHr where QB Fancher was replaced by Cole Pennington (former MU QB star Chad's son) while SALa only beat Ark St 21-14 as QB Bradley came back (19-25-145, 2 td's). SALa's defense is holding teams to 76 ypg under their avg (#15) and the Herd have avg'd just 266 ypg the L/4 gms. In SBC play SALa is +138 ypg while MU is -90 ypg and the L/4 gms SALa is +136 ypg while MU is -139 ypg. MU has failed to cover their L/4 road gms and we think SALa, with the stronger defense (#36/#90) wins by 2 td's at home.

Boise St by 3 over UTAH ST - Boise has won & covered the L/6 games vs Utah St. Both teams enter this game with 5 wins with 2 weeks left to play. Boise made the switch and started QB Madsen LW but both he & Green split reps and over the past 3 gms Boise's offense is avg'g 472 ypg/35 ppg despite not having RB Jeanty the past 2 gms. USU plays much better at home (+142 ypg) while Boise is -21 ypg on the road this season. USU QB Legas is back under center and the Aggies have 2 talented WR's in Royals and Vaughn and Boise does have the #101 pass D. USU is 4-1 ATS at home TY and we think they keep this game with Boise close and with Boise just firing HC Avalos, it is unknown where the morale and mindset of the team is with 2 gms left.

WISCONSIN by 10 over Nebraska - Neb hasn't won here s/ '66 but have covered the L/3 matchups. The visitor is 3-3 SU but 6-0 ATS. The Badgers are 10-1 SU & 7-4 ATS in B10 play. Both def rank top 25 in the nation but the over has hit the last 4 of 5 matchups. Wisky QB Mordecai and RB Allen came back from inj LW but it did not help as they fell as a 12 pt home fav 24-10 LW vs NW. Neb (+2) lost QB Haarberg to injury in the 2Q and turnover prone Jeff Sims threw had 3 TO's as Wisky lost 13-10 vs MD. Wisky has failed to cover 5 of their L/6 but if Sims starts for Nebraska on the road we like the Badgers to force turnovers and win by DD's.

Tuesday 11/21

Eastern Michigan at BUFFALO - Just the 11th meeting since Buffalo joined the MAC in 1999. After losing the first 5 meetings (1-4 ATS) Buffalo is 4-1 SU & ATS since 2013 incl winning & covering 3 straight. LY Buffalo pulled the 50-31 upset as a 6' pt AD finishing with a 498-327 yd edge. LY's combined 81 pts was a series high & easily went over 59 pt total. In fact the teams have combined to go Over the game Total 7 of 9 mtgs incl 5 straight. Depending on LW's results EM could be playing for bowl elig & UB could be playing for the MAC East or both could be closing out disappointing losing seasons. Will one of these be our final regular season Tues Nite Marquee?

Bowling Green at WESTERN MICHIGAN - Broncos are 6-2 SU & ATS vs Falcons s/'05. Seven of their last nine mtgs since '04 have gone Under the expected total. That includes LY when BG pulled out a 13-9 win but failed to cover as a 4' pt HF being outgained 319-291. If Broncos won LW they are playing for bowl eligibility, while BG is already bowl eligible. The last Tuesday Nite Marquee of the regular season will be available Tues after Noon EST for just \$12 at 1-800-654-3448.

With DEN struggling as home chalk with just a 1-7-1 ATS run, we'll call for the visitor to grab the outright win in this one as they continue to get back in the NFC playoff mix. **FORECAST: Minnesota by 10**

3★ DETROIT over Chicago - Following a 41-38 win against the Chargers where we cashed a Top Play 3.5★ LP and 4★ Newsletter Winner (DET 533-421 yd edge), the Lions are back inside of Ford Field for the next 2 weeks to take on a pair of DIV foes in CHI and GB (Thur). The Bears meanwhile had their lone Soldier Field contest in a 5-wk span last Thur against the Panthers (21-12 FD & 295-213 yd edges in 3 pt win). After dropping 7 of 8 meetings with the Bears heading into LY, the Lions picked up the series sweep in '22 including a 41-10 (-5) home win that saw CHI held to just 9 FD's and 230 yards. With DET covering 11 consec NFC North contests and the Bears struggling in their own DIV meetings (2-12 ATS), the Lions put a beatdown on the visitor in this one (DET 7-2 ATS as a HF). **FORECAST: DETROIT by 17**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ MIAMI over Las Vegas - The Raiders moved to 2-0 under interim HC Pierce following a 4 pt home victory over the Jets where they had a 365-274 yd disadvantage. They now head to South Beach to take on a well-rested Dolphins squad that's on a 5-1-1 ATS run after their bye week. The Raiders (-4) picked up a 31-28 OT victory in their most recent meeting back in '21 with 28-22 FD and 497-330 yard edges. They have however failed to cover 6 of their past 7 AG's. With the Dolphins 14-4 ATS as a HF the L3Y including a perfect 4-0 TY with an avg cover of 15 ppg, the Raiders are in for a long afternoon. **FORECAST: MIAMI by 17**

OTHER PLAYS

Cincinnati at BALTIMORE - Thursday - The Ravens are inside of MT&T Bank for a 3rd consec week following a 37-3 blowout of the Seahawks and a 33-31 (-6) to the Browns where they blew a 2 TD lead in the 4Q (CLE GW 40-yd FG as time expired). They now take on a Bengals squad that suffered a 3 pt home loss to the Texans who finished with a 544-380 yd edge and connected on a GW 38-yd FG of their own at the end of regulation (QB Burrow 27-40-347-2-2). In their Wk 2 matchup earlier TY in CIN, the Ravens (+3) finished with 26-19 FD and 415-282 yd edges in a 27-24 upset win. Although the recent ATS trends are fully in favor of the visiting Bengals in this one (CIN 6-1-1 ATS as an AD & 17-5-1 ATS overall), we're expecting another one-score AFC North battle that goes down to the very end. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

CLEVELAND by 1 over Pittsburgh - After a shocking comeback win (trailed 31-17 in 4Q) LW in BAL where they finished with a 373-306 yd edge (GW 40-yd FG w/00 left), the Browns are at home for the only time in a 4-wk span (trips to DEN & LAR on deck) to take on a Steelers squad that picked up a 4 pt home win LW against the Packers despite being outgained for the 9th straight game to begin the ssn (GB 399-324 yd edge). In their MNF matchup back in Wk 2, the Steelers (+2) were aided by a pair of def TD's in the 26-22 upset victory (CLE 20-9 FD and 408-255 yd edges). While the Browns have been dominant at home TY with a 4-1 ATS mark and allowing an avg of just 10 ppg and 161 ypg, the Steelers (10-2 ATS as a DIV AD) always find a way to keep their AFC North contests close.

HOUSTON by 8 over Arizona - Following another surprising victory LW in CIN where they hit a GW 38-yd FG as time expired (QB Stroud 23-39-356-1-1, 2nd straight last second comeback), the Texans are back at home for the next 3 wks. Up first is a Cardinals squad that picked up a 25-23 home victory (GW 23-yd FG as time expired) a week ago against the Falcons in the debut of Kyle Murray under center (282 tll yds, TD). The most recent matchup came back in '21 with the Cardinals (-19) picking up an easy 31-5 victory with 24-8 FD and 397-160 yard advantages. Although the Texans have failed to cover 10 of their past 12 as home chalk, we expect them to get the job done here as while Cardinals were outstanding as an AD the previous 2 yrs with a 10-3 ATS mark, the '23 campaign has been a challenge with 4 straight ATS defeats (18 pt avg loss).

La Chargers by 6 over GREEN BAY - The Chargers are back on the road for a 2nd time in 3 weeks following a home meeting with the Lions where they all'd a GW 41-yd FG as time expired (QB Herbert 27-40-323-4-1). The Packers have now dropped 5 of their L/6 after a 4 pt defeat LW in PIT where they finished with a 399-324 yd edge (GB -2 TO's). In their last meeting back in '19, the Chargers (+4) ended a 7-game losing streak to the Packers with 24-13 FD and 442-184 yard edges. While the Packers had covered their L/3 as a HD (2-0-1 SU) heading into '23, they haven't been as fortunate TY with losses to DIV foes DET and MIN (14 pt avg defeat). With the Chargers covering 4 straight when laying points, we have no issue leaning in their direction for this one.

WASHINGTON by 3 over NY Giants - This marks the only HG in a 4-wk span for the Commanders who return to D.C. after splitting their 2-gm road trip to NE (3 pt win) and SEA (all'd GW 43-yd FG w/00 left, QB Howell 29-44-312-3-0) with a Thanksgiving trip to DAL on deck. The Giants meanwhile are away from home for a 3rd consec week after blowout losses in LV (24 pt defeat) and DAL where they were held to just 172 yds in a 49-17 defeat (DAL 32 FD's & 640 yds!). Ironically, the Giants most recent victory came back in Wk 7 against this very same WAS squad as they held the Commanders to just 273 yds in a 14-7 home upset (+3). With WAS failing to cover 7 of their L/9 has a HF and 6 of the past 7 meetings staying within 8 pts, the Giants keep this one closer than expected as they're 8-2 ATS as a DIV AD.

JACKSONVILLE by 3 over Tennessee - The Titans are on the road for a 3rd consec week following a trip to TB that saw them held to just 6 pts and 209 yds in a 14 pt loss. This is actually just TEN's 2nd DIV contest overall on the year and first against JAX who's back at home for a 2nd straight week after being dismantled by the 49ers ending their 5-gm winning streak (SF 437-221 yd edge, 3★ LP Winner on Under 45!). The Jaguars picked up the series sweep of the Titans a year ago including a 20-16 (-6) win in the ssn finale that saw them crowned the AFC South Champs (JAX key 37-yd FR TD w/2:51 left). The Titans haven't won outright away from Nashville since the midway point of LY (0-9 SU/2-6-1 ATS). They have however covered 10 of their past 15 overall AFC South contests while JAX is just 3-11 ATS as a HF.

Dallas by 14 over CAROLINA - This marks the only AG for the Cowboys in a 5-wk span as they head to Charlotte following a 32 pt home win against the Giants (32-16 FD & 640-172 yd edges) with 3 more matchups in DAL on deck including B2B Thur visits from WAS and SEA. The Panthers on the other hand are at home for the only time in their own 5-wk span (trips to TEN, TB & NO on deck) after a trip last Thur to the "Windy City" where they were held to just 213 yds in a 16-13 defeat. In their most recent meeting back in '21, the Cowboys (-4) picked up a 36-28 victory behind Dak Prescott's 4 TD performance. With DAL a solid 9-4 ATS as away chalk and CAR failing to cover 7 of their L/9 overall, the visitor gets the 2 TD edge in this one.

SAN FRANCISCO by 14 over Tampa Bay - This marks the only HG for the 49ers in a 4-wk span as they smashed the Jags LW in JAX (437-221 yd edge) and have a pair of key trips to SEA (Thur) and PHI on deck. The Bucs meanwhile finished with a 340-209 yd edge and held the Titans to just 2 FG's in a 14 pt victory. In their late ssn trip to the Bay Area a year ago, the Bucs (+3) trailed 35-0 in the 3Q of an eventual 28 pt defeat (SF 404-322 yd edge). While the Bucs have covered each of their 4 AG's on the ssn (all as dogs) including a pair of outright victories, the 49ers add on to their already impressive 13-2 ATS mark as home chalk in this one.

Seattle by 3 over LA RAMS - Following a narrow 3 pt home victory over the Commanders where they connected on a GW 43-yd FG as time expired (QB Smith 31-47-369-2-0), the Seahawks begin a stretch of challenging contests (SF, DAL, SF, PHI on deck) with a trip to LA to take on a Rams squad that returns to action after a much needed bye week (lost prior 3 SU/ATS by 16 ppg). After dropping both matchups with the Seahawks a year ago, the Rams (+5) went into SEA in the ssn opener and picked up a 30-13 upset thanks in part to huge FD (27-13) and yard (426-180) edges. The Rams are hoping to have QB Stafford back here (missed most of L/2 gms w/in) as bkp Rypien struggled in the loss in Lambeau (13-28-130-0-1). With the Seahawks having issues as a DIV AF with failed covers in 5 of the L/6, we're cutting off our lean at a FG and letting Vegas decide which team we're siding with once Stafford's status is discovered.

BUFFALO by 3 over NY Jets - The Bills are back at home on short rest following a MNF matchup against the Broncos on MNF. The Jets meanwhile suffered a 2nd straight defeat LW on the road in LV where they were held to just 4 FG's in a 4 pt loss (NYJ 365-274 yd edge). These 2 met on MNF back in Wk 1 with the Jets (+2) getting a surprising 22-16 OT victory with a GW 65 yd PR TD in the extra frame (NYJ trailed 13-3 at HT). While revenge is on the mind of the Bills in this one, keep in mind that they've failed to cover 6 of their L/9 home matchups as of presstime and have a huge trip on deck to take on the Eagles.

Philadelphia at KANSAS CITY - MNF - Arguably the most anticipated regular ssn game in 2023 with the Eagles looking to get revenge from LY's 38-35 Super Bowl loss (KC GW 27-yd FG w/08 left). That win by the Chiefs was their 4th straight against the Eagles dating back to '13. We'll find out a lot about the Eagles over the next month or so as they have meetings against BUF, SF, DAL and SEA coming up. The Chiefs meanwhile return to action following week off (Andy Reid 27-4 SU all-time after a bye incl his time as HC of the Eagles). While KC is a solid 8-1 ATS in meetings with the NFC, something will have to give in this one as the Eagles are also an impressive 7-3 ATS in their own non-conf contests.
