4★ Boise St over HAWAII - Boise St has won the last 7 meetings vs Hawaii both SU/ATS. Last wk Boise beat CSU 52-21 (outgained 315-291) as they scored 3 TD's on blk'd kicks (2 punts/1 FG) while UH lost 34-10 at SDSt. Boise QB Bachmeier was back last wk (202, 1 td) but Boise has dealt with inj's on OFF & is only putting up 301 ypg the L/2 gms. However UH's DEF is giving up 414 ypg & their run D is all g' 252 ypg (5.4) but Boise has been w/o their top RB Holani (missed L/2 gms with inj). UH's OFF has shown the ability to both run well (323 vs Fresno) and pass (410 vs NMex) and faces a Boise DEF that is giving up 394 ypg incl 220 rush ypg (4.7). UH is 0-4-1 ATS the L3Y as a MW HD and Boise is 3-0 ATS this ssn as DD chalk vs MW foes. We'll go with the series history here & give a strong lean to the Broncos as our top play!

FORECAST: Boise St by 27

3★ Lsu over ARKANSAS - Arkansas is 0-4 SU vs LSU but have covered the last 2. The Hogs were 6-0 ATS this season entering last week's gm vs Florida but HC Pittman was forced to miss the gm due to Covid. Arkansas allowed a ssn high 593 yds and lost 63-35 with their final td coming with just :40 left. LSU had their gm cancelled vs Bama LW. The last time we saw LSU play they got crushed 48-11 by Aub but their previous 2 losses were followed by blowout wins of 34 & 28 pts. The Tigers will likely still be w/o QB Brennan. LSU is allowing 137 ypg more than foes avg but Ark is putting up 12 ypg less than their foes allow. LY LSU was fav'd by 42 pts & now they are a 2 point dog! We think the rest will help LSU regroup and play their best gm while Ark may be running out of good fortune so we will call for LSU to win by a touchdown. Geaux Tigers!

FORECAST: Lsu by 7

3★ NEVADA over San Diego St - Nev has covered 4 of the L/6 gms vs SDSU and have pulled the outright upset the L/2 years despite getting outgained in both gms. Nev only beat NMex 27-20 while SDSU won 34-10 vs UH (4★ LP winner on UNDER 52!) Nev is rolling this ssn led by QB Strong (1517, 71%, 12-1) and overall the OFF is avg'g 482 ypg! However they face a SDSU DEF that is all g' just 244 ypg & holding foes to 125 ypg under their ssn avg. The Nev DEF is playing well this ssn as well, holding teams to 318 ypg. SDSU's rush attack is back this ssn (340 ypg, 6.8 ypc in wins) but in their loss to SJSU they were held to 101 yds (2.2) and Nev's rush D has held tms to 126 ypg (3.7) this ssn. Nev is 5-1 ATS as a MW HD under Norvell incl a 37-34 OT win vs WY as a HD this season and we call for the Wolfpack to pull the upset.

FORECAST: NEVADA by 6

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Wake Forest over Duke - WF is 7-2 SU and have covered 4 of the L/5. The home team is just 2-7 SU and covered only 1 of the L/5. LTH Duke was DD chalk but WF needed a win to get bowl elig and they embarrassed the Blue Devils on Senior Day 59-7. WF put up 53 pts and a ssn high 606 yds LW but lost by 6 at NC. The Deacons actually led 45-24 3Q. Duke was crushed by NC, 56-24 2 weeks ago. The Blue Devils avg 19 ypg less than their foes allow and QB Brice has thrown 12 int's this ssn. WF avg 8 ypg more than their foes allow and QB Hartman has an 8-0 ratio. Against 5 common foes (Cuse, UVA, VT, NCSt & NC), WF is 3-2 SU/4-1 ATS, +7.8 ppg & -4 ypg while Duke is 1-4 SU/ATS, -10.8 ppg & -22.8 ypg. Duke is dangerous as a home dog but the visitor owns this series and WF has ply'd much better against their common foes.

FORECAST: Wake Forest by 13

2★ Florida over VANDERBILT - FL absolutely demolished Vandy LY, winning 56-0 and finishing w/a 560-128 yd edge. The Gators are 28-1 SU in this series and have covered the last 3. The home team is only 7-16 ATS. QB Trask was w/o TE Pitts last week but still put up 356 yds and 6 td passes vs Ark in FL's 63-35 (-16) win. Vandy allowed 38 pts vs KY's struggling OFF but added 2 td's in the final 3:13 to get within a fg. Vandy is allowing 35 ypg more than their foes avg while FL avg 113 ypg more than their foes allow. QB Trask has a 28-3 ratio and faces our #109 pass eff D. Vandy is 2-11 as a HD and HC Mullen is 6-2 as an AF so we can see this getting ugly quick, just like last year, which is why we call for the Gators to win by more than 5 td's.

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 18TH

Northern Illinois at BALL ST - Have played for the Bronze Stalk Trophy since 2008 but LY was just 2nd time the Cardinals took home the Trophy as they won 27-20 as a 4 pt AD. Both are 0-2 ATS TY. Ball St had a come-from-behind win LW after trailing by as much as 14 to EM they scored a GW td w/:06 left tow win 38-31 as a 9 pt HF. NIU looks to be headed for a 2nd straight disappointing ssn. In their opener NIU only trailed Buffalo 21-16 at HT but lost by 19 as a 13' HD. LY they only trailed CM 9-0 at HT as a 7' pt HD but trailed 40-3 before a garbage td w/:11 left. Prior to LY's loss the Huskies had won 10 straight in the series going 8-2 ATS including 7 straight covers.

Toledo at EASTERN MICHIGAN - Last meeting here the Eagles won 28-26 as a 1' pt HD, that ended an 11 game losing streak to the Rockets. LW both teams blew DD 2H leads. Toledo scored with 2:54 left to take a 38-28 lead as a 2' pt AD but allowed WM to score 13 in the final :45 to lose. We won our Wednesday Night Marquee on EM LW as a 9 pt AD. They led Ball ST 24-13 in the 3Q & after falling behind 31-24 tied the gm late 4Q but allowed a GW td w/:06 left. LY UT won 37-34 in OT but EM has covered 4 straight in the series with the last 3 gms decided by 5 pts or less.

Western Michigan at CENTRAL MICHIGAN - Played for the Victory Cannon. This is the rivals 92nd all-time meeting with WM leading the all-time series 50-39-2. Both are 2-0 ATS. CM is off an easy 40-10 win as a 7' pt AF over a poor NIU tm. WM took on a much tougher Toledo, with a Miracle comeback with 2 td's in the final :45 for a 41-38 win as a 2' pt HF. The Broncos are 5-1 SU (3-3 ATS) vs CM since '14 & the visitor is has covered 8 straight. LY after losing to WM 31-15 as a 16' pt AD, CM won 6 of their L/7 reg ssn gms & won the Div. This game could eventually decide the MAC West as the teams are tied (2-0) for lead in the division & the winner will hold the tiebreaker. We won both of our Marquees LW on the MAC games, who will be the winner this week?

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 19TH

Utah St at WYOMING - Bridger's Battle, USU leads series 40-26-4 SU. Before LY WY had won 3 straight ATS, and the home tm is on a 6-2 ATS run. WY comes in just 1-2 SU/ATS and had their last gm cancelled while USU dropped to 0-4 SU/ATS. USU's OFF is only putting up 243 ypg/11 ppg and are -283 ypg so far! WY's DEF comes in holding foes to 64 ypg under their ssn avg while their OFF, led by RB Valladay (397, 4.8) is putting up 406 ypg but the OL all'd 6 sks in their last gm. However USU's DEF comes in all g' 526 ypg & giving up 116 ypg above what their foes avg. USU is just 1-6 ATS the L3Y as a MW dog while WY is 8-1 ATS as a MW HF under HC Bohl.

Tulane at TULSA - From '05-'16 Tulane was 1-11 SU/ATS vs Tulsa, but have won L/3 both SU/ATS. Tulane is off a 38-12 win vs Army (3★ LP Winner!) while Tulsa came back & beat SMU 28-24 (trailed 24-7 HT). Tulane's OFF has turned it on the L/3 gms putting up 455 ypg/38 ppg (incl 244, 6.5 rush L/3 gms) while their DEF is holding foes to 304 ypg/12 ppg in the L/3 gms. Tulane is all g' 304 pass ypg vs AAC foes & faces Tulsa QB Smith (271 ypg vs AAC foes) and a OFF that is avg'g 446 ypg/35 ppg vs conf foes. Tulsa's D is also stopping the run, giving up just 133 ypg (3.6) & are holding AAC foes to 78 ypg under their ssn avg. While Tulsa is playing well they are off a big home win & are now ranked for the 1st time in 10 yrs & are 0-3 ATS as an AAC HF the L2Y while Tulane is on a 5-0 ATS run vs AAC foes.

MARQUEE SELECTIONS

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FRIDAY NOVEMBER 20TH

LOUISVILLE by 28 over Syracuse - UL is 8-2 SU/7-2 ATS in this series and their L/5 series wins have come by 29.6 ppg. The Cards are just 2-6 this ssn but they are +47 ypg and they've held the yards edge in 4 of their losses. Last week UL held a +110 yd edge over UVA but lost 31-17 (+3) partly thanks to 3 TO's including an 85 yd pick 6. Cuse enters off a bye and has lost 5 straight. The Orange are -201 ypg and have yet to hold the yds edge over a single foe. The Cardinals have a huge edge on offense, avg 48 ypg more than their foes allow. Cuse started true frosh QB Jacobian Morgan in their last game 2 wks ago and they avg 136 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. We will call for UL to continue their dominance of the Orange by nearly 4 td's.

MINNESOTA by 3 over Purdue - Minn is 6-1 SU with 2 straight covers in this series. LY Pur lost their starting QB and star WR in the 1Q and Minn led 28-10 w/a 340-178 yd edge at half but only won 38-31 (-1). The Boilermakers have yet to get WR Moore in the lineup this year and their offense has sputtered. LW we went against Purdue as our top play on these pages along with a 4★ LPS. Pur never led and lost 27-20 (+3). Minn trailed 35-0 (+3) vs Iowa last Fri and didn't score their only td until :14 left. QB Morgan hasn't been nearly as impressive this ssn, completing just 58% (4-4 ratio) but he did hit his F/14 passes when he faced Pur LY. The Gophers have been gashed for 238 (7.2) rush ypg but Pur is only rushing for 61 (2.5) this year. Pur is only 4-8 the L2Y as chalk so we will call for the Gophers to pull a home upset.

AIR FORCE by 12 over New Mexico - NMex holds a 8-2 ATS record s/10 over AF, but the home team is on a 5-1 ATS run. AF has not played since Oct 31 due to covid issues while NMex is playing & practicing in Vegas due to covid issues in their state. NMex is off a 27-20 loss to Nev (QB Tuioiti DNP inj) and this ssn are avg'g 431 ypg on OFF, led by their run game (190 ypg, 4.7). But the Lobo DEF is giving up 491 ypg & are all g' foes to gain 86 ypg above their ssn avg. In their last gm AF ran for 415 yds (6.3) vs Boise despite not having several key players on OFF. It is unknown who will be available here, however it seems likes no matter who plays for AF they have a chance to hang around. AF was 3-1 ATS LY as a MW HF while NMex is 6-12 ATS as a MW dog the L3Y.

FAU by 35 over UMass - First mtg. This gm was scheduled just a few wks ago. The Owls just won last Fri, beating rival FIU 38-19 (-9). RFR QB Javian Posey sparked the offense in his first career start LW, leading FAU to a ssn high 461 yds while rushing for 182. UMass has ply'd 2 gms this year, getting outscored 92-10 in those but are 1-1 ATS. The Minutemen are allowing 282 (6.9) rush ypg and are -275 ypg. UMass has also been held under 200 yds in both gms. FAU is 0-2-1 as chalk of 20 points or more but we can't help but give the Owls the lean here against a UMass squad that is just trying to scrap together some football games.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 21ST

OREGON by 21 over UCLA - This marks the 2nd trip back to Eugene for UCLA HC Kelly (UO HC '09-'12) who saw his Bruins get knocked off by 21 (+10) back in '18. In fact, UCLA has now dropped 6 consec road trips here by a 42-20 avg score. The Bruins had their gm vs Utah cancelled LW so they threw together a gm vs Cal on Sunday and won 34-10. The Ducks meanwhile overcame a DD deficit in the 2Q to knock off the Cougs in Pullman by 14 (UO 581-421 yd edge, -3 TO's). The Bruins have now dropped 3 consec P12 AG's SU & ATS with 23 pt avg defeat. UO on the other hand has won 9 consec P12 HG's (5-4 ATS) including a 35-14 (-10) win over Stanford in their opener which should give them some confidence in this one.

PENN ST by 4 over Iowa - PSU is 6-0 SU/4-1-1 ATS in this series but the last 3 have been decided by 6 pts or less. LY Iowa held a 356-294 yd edge but 2 TO's led to 10 PSU points in their 17-12 (+3) loss. Last week PSU entered 0-3 as road chalk vs Neb. The Nittany Lions fell behind 27-6 but benched QB Clifford and QB Will Lewis sparked the offense. They got within a td but was SOD at the Neb 11 & 13 and finished +203 yds! Iowa led Minn 35-0 (-3) LW and the Gophers didn't score until :14 left. The Hawkeyes are +62 ypg and their 2 losses were by just 5 comb'd pts while they've won 2 str by 42 & 28. PSU is +77 ypg and also has 2 close losses. Iowa has been impressive the last 2 wks but PSU looked like a different team with Lewis under center. PSU is 2-6 as a HF and 0-4 ATS this year but they are a desperate team and we'll call for them to get their first win.

PITTSBURGH by 3 over Virginia Tech - We used Under 44 in DC Foster's last home game LY as our Totals GOY and the Hokies pitched a 28-0 shutout! Pitt is actually 5-1 SU and have covered 9 straight when hosting VT. Pitt had their gm vs GT cancelled last week due to their own Covid issues. QB Pickett ret'd the week prior and Pitt crushed FSU 41-17. LW the Hokies were off a surprise loss to Liberty but was home chalk vs Miami, who was shorthanded due to Covid. VT gave up the go-ahead td w/5:59 left and didn't reach UM territory on their L/3 possessions. Pitt has held 3 foes to ssn low yds and they didn't miss DB Ford (opted out) much in their last gm, considering his replacement, Brandon Hill, was the ACC DB of week. Pitt has 33 sks and VT just all'd 6 vs UM. Narduzzi is 17-9 with 9 outright upsets as an ACC dog and we can't ignore VT's struggles in Heinz Stadium so Pitt gets the call for the upset here.

MIAMI, FL by 21 over Georgia Tech - UM is out for revenge after losing LY as 18 pt chalk. The 'Canes gave up a fake punt for td, a fum recovery in the EZ and had a GW fg blk'd before losing in OT. GT had their gm vs Pitt cancelled LW. UM was short handed (missing 13 ply'rs) but still managed to beat VTech, giving us a 2★ winner on these pages and a 3★ LPS winner. The Jackets are -98 ypg and have lost 3 straight prior to LW. UM is +46 ypg and their OFF avg 50 ypg more than their foes allow. GT is giving up 43 ypg more than their foes avg. The Jackets are just 1-3 as 20+ pt dogs under HC Collins and this year their 5 losses have come by 17, 18, 21, 28 & 67 but HC Diaz is only 3-7 as DD chalk so we can't give the 'Canes a strong lean here.

East Carolina by 3 over TEMPLE - Temp holds a 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS record vs ECU as AAC foes, but ECU's lone cover was LY (27-17 loss as an 11'-point dog). Both tms enter with just 1 win & are riding a 4-gm losing streak. Temp did not have QB Russo again last wk (missed L/3 gms) & RB Davis is not with the tm any more (Portal) & that has led to Temp avg'g 293 ypg the L/3 gms. The ECU OFF has been a bit better this ssn, avg'g 400 ypg vs AAC foes & they face a Temp D that is giving up 490 ypg the L/4 gms. The ECU D is not any better as they have all'd 525 ypg/42 ppg the L/3 gms. We'll back ECU by a FG as HC Houston is 4-2 ATS as a conf dog here while Temp is 0-2 ATS as chalk TY and could be w/o their QB again while ECU has a vet QB in Ahlers.

Cincinnati by 10 over UCF - As AAC foes the home team has won 4 of 5 ATS, and LY Cincy (+4) pulled the upset at home 27-24. This will be a battle of an explosive UCF OFF (619 ypg/44 ppg) led by QB Gabriel (2774, 63%, 23-2) taking on a Cincy D that is all g' just 295 ypg/11 ppg vs AAC foes & are holding AAC foes to 162 ypg under their ssn avg. The UCF D has held their L/3 foes to 355 ypg but in their F/4 gms they all'd 518 ypg & face a Cincy OFF led by QB Ridder (1483, 67%, 14-6, 469 rush, 8.8 ypc, 9 td) that has put up 529 ypg/46 ppg the L/4 gms. UCF is also missing several key DEF s'trs. UCF is 0-4 ATS as AAC HD (has not been AAC HD s/'16) & while Cincy is just 2-4 ATS as an AAC AF under HC Fickell, he has this tm on a mission this season.

GEORGIA by 21 over Mississippi St - MSU is 0-2 in Athens and the Dawgs won the last mtg 31-3 in '17. Both tms had their games cancelled LW. UGA was beat up entering their gm vs Florida 2 weeks ago and lost 44-28 (-3). QB Bennett was inj'd (shoulder) in that gm. Bkp QB Mathis ply'd the 2H but USC transfer JT Daniels was getting majority 1st tm reps in practice before they were cancelled LW. MSU has yet to cover a game since winning their opener (0-5 ATS run). MSU is -34 ypg on the season but their defense holds foes 60 ypg below their avg (#22 in FBS). UGA is putting up 11 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. We expect a low scoring affair and their is some concern that Daniels could spark the Dawgs offense but MSU's defense is good enough to keep this game closer than expected and UGA's defense could still be missing multiple starters.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 4 over Appalachian St - 4th mtg as SBC foes, App St holds a 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS record. CCar had their game last wk PPD, so they have an extra week to prep for this big gm, while App St barely beat GS last wk 17-13. CCar's run D has all'd 113 ypg (3.7) vs SBC foes but faces an App St run gm that is putting up 256 ypg (5.5) vs SBC foes. App St's D is holding foes to 62 ypg under their ssn avg, but faces CCar r/r QB McCall (1393, 69%, 16-1) and a CCar OFF putting 462 ypg/37 ppg vs SBC foes. CCar is 0-4 ATS as an SBC HF & App St is in a rare role as an SBC dog (1-0 ATS LY) but lost QB Thomas to a scary inj last week (status here ?) and we'll back CCar here with App St possibly missing their best OFF player.

Clemson by 31 over FLORIDA ST - CU has won 5 straight including 3-0 ATS, winning the L/3 by 32 ppg. The Tigers enter fresh off a bye and are angry off their loss to Notre Dame. QB Lawrence is expected to return. Prior to LW's game, FSU announced their top 2 ply'rs DT Wilson & WR Terry wouldn't return this ssn. FSU switched to true frosh QB Chubba Purdy last week in their 38-22 loss (+10') at NCSt. FSU is allowing 68% completions and they are only #99 in our pass D rankings. CU has held 5 of their opponents to ssn low yards and they should be healthier coming off the bye. FSU is allowing foes to put up 83 ypg more than their avg. CU is 9-4-1 as an AF and on a 19-7-1 ATS run but both tms have failed to cover 3 straight so we'll give a slight lean to the underdog 'Noles.
Navy by 4 over USF - As AAC foes the home squad is 3-0 ATS incl Navy (-15) winning 35-3 LY. Navy has not played since Oct 31 at SMU (2 gms PPD, covid) while USF lost their 7th gm in a row last wk. In their 3 AAC mtgs USF has all'd 393 rush ypg (6.5) to Navy & this ssn their run D has all'd 208 ypg (4.9). Navy's rush attack this ssn is not as strong, only avg'g 187 ypg (3.8) and their OL has all'd 16 sks in 93 pass att! USF's OFF is getting held to 107 ypg under what their AAC foes allow but could have some success here against a Navy D giving 445 ypg & a DEF that has not played in 3 wks. We'll call for Navy by just over a FG though as Navy is 9-4 ATS as an AF vs AAC foes under HC Niunatalolo while USF is just 3-7 ATS the L3Y as a HD.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 1 over Missouri - LY MO had a 247-30 yd edge at half yet only led 17-14 after SC scored on the 1st play of the 2H. MO held SC scoreless the rest of the way & won 34-14 (-9'). MO had their gm vs UGA cancelled LW. SC led Ole Miss 42-38 (+13') 40 then allowed 3 td's in the L/12 minutes. The Gamecocks are -216 ypg in their L/4 and they let go of HC Muschamp on Sunday! MO was blown out in their most recent gm vs FL but they did pull the upset over LSU earlier TY and SC lost to the Tigers 52-24. RB Smith had 243 rush (9.7) last week but will face a MO defense that only allows 132 (4.0) rush ypg. The Tigers are holding foes 44 ypg below their avg while SC is allowing foes to put up 35 ypg more than their avg. MO is 1-6 as an AF and SC's Interim HC, Mike Bobo, has plenty of experience so we think he pulls the Gamecocks together for an upset.

MARYLAND by 11 over Michigan St - MD is 0-3 SU but also 3-1 ATS in this series. LY the Terps were more than 3 td dogs but only lost 22-19 in the ssn finale. MD had their gm vs OSU cancelled LW due to their own Covid issues. We went against Mich St as a 4★ LPS for the 2nd straight week and picked up a winner with Indiana posting a 24-0 shutout (-7'). Sparty is avg just 239 ypg in their L/2 and their defense is allowing 41 ypg more than their foes allow. MD became the first team since at least 1978 to pull B2B upsets as dogs of 18 pts or more. Now the Terps switch roles as chalk but their Covid issues could leave them shorthanded. MSU is on a 10-20 ATS run and MD is 5-1 as home chalk. We like the Terps here but their Covid issues are concerning.

OHIO ST by 13 over Indiana - OSU is 26-0-1 SU in this series and Indiana hasn't beat the Buckeyes since 1988. IU is 7-2 ATS and had covered 5 straight in Columbus prior to LY when OSU won 51-10 (-17'). The Buckeyes were cancelled LW and didn't look nearly as dominant in their F/2 gms. They were tied mid Q2 vs Neb and after building a 35-3 halftime lead, allowed Rutgers to put up 24 pts in the 2H two wks ago. We had a 4★ LPS winner with IU LW in their 24-0 shutout over Mich St (-7'). The Hoosiers are 4-0 in Big 10 play for the first time s/1987. LY OSU held foes 143 ypg below their avg, but only 28 ypg TY and IU is holding foes 62 ypg below their avg. While we can't call for the upset, we will gladly lean with the underdog Hoosiers who are 5-0 as away dogs!

Liberty by 1 over NC STATE - NCSt won the last mtg when Lib was an FCS school in '11, 43-21. The Wolfpack enter off a 38-22 (-10') win over a shorthanded FSU squad starting a true frosh QB. NCSt led 28-3 2Q and FSU's final td came in 3bn time. QB Hockman threw for a car high 265 yds. Liberty looks to knock off their 3rd ACC foe this ssn after upsetting VT 2 weeks ago. The Flames are well rested after crushing FCS Western Carolina LW. QB Willis has a 15-1 ratio and has rushed for 700 (7.1) yds this ssn. NCSt is allowing 30 ypg more than foes allow while Liberty avg 68 ypg more than their foes allow. NCSt has certainly ply'd a tougher sked but Liberty has pulled 2 upsets as DD dogs and we think they will keep this close so we will barely call for the upset.

Michigan by 10 over RUTGERS - Rut is 0-5 SU in this series and lost 52-0 LY. All 5 losses have come by at least 21 pts. We can't imagine anyone having confidence in Mich after LW's 49-11 (+6') home loss vs Wisky. The Wolverines trailed 28-0 at half and have now lost 3 straight. Rut was Big 10 chalk for the first time since 2015 LW vs Illinois but lost 23-20 (-6) despite leading 20-10 3Q. There could be a change at QB for Mich after Harbaugh benched Joe Milton in favor of Cade McNamara. Rut is -88 ypg after finishing -241 ypg vs B10 foes LY. Mich is -49 ypg. It's hard to put much faith in the Wolverines but Rut just lost to ILL and Harbaugh has shown he can dominate the lesser B10 teams.

MARSHALL by 14 over Charlotte - MU is out for revenge after losing LY 24-13 (-7). The Herd led 10-7 at half but the 49ers finished w/a 422-230 yd edge and got bowl elig for the first time ever. LW MU was more than 3 td chalk but still covered with a 42-14 win and finished w/a 520-303 yd edge. UC is -25 ypg on the ssn and are playing their first game this month! The Herd are +191 ypg and are holding foes 56 ypg below their avg. UC allows 213 rush ypg (5.9) and faces RB Knox who has topped 100 rush in 5 of 7 gms. MU has won every game by DD's this year including a 10 pt win over App St. UC lost to App St by 15 pts and was out'd by 226 yds. MU is only 7-15 as HF and ply'g with unbeaten pressure so we will call for UC to stay within 2 td's.

ARMY by 3 over Georgia Southern - First meeting. Despite outpacing TXSt 437-299 GS only won 40-48 (TXSt KR TD & short TD drive off TO) while Army lost at Tulane 38-12 (-3 TO's). It is option vs option here & both tms know what to expect. GS lost top RB King (ACL) but still ran for 386 yds last wk (QB Werts 120 rush, 3 td, bkp RB Wright 103 yds) & over the L/3 gms have ran for 321 ypg (5.5) and the Army run D has all'd 184 ypg (5.8) vs their L/2 FBS foes. While the Army option is putting up 303 ypg (5.3) they do face a GS run D all'g only 93 ypg (3.5). After 2 wks off Army looked rusty last wk & while we like them to win, we think GS could keep this gm close with their similar styles chewing the clock & limiting the number of possessions.

Usc by 6 over UTAH - The host has won 7 straight by 9 ppg including LY when the Trojans (+3') knocked off a #10 Utes squad by a 30-23 score (Utah 457-381 yd edge). For a 2nd consec week the Trojans needed a late 4Q TD to survive (498-444 yd edge in 4 pt win in Tucson). The Utes meanwhile saw their 2nd consec game canceled due to Covid. LTH the Trojans trailed by 20 in the 4Q and finished with a ssn-low 205 yds (all'd ssn-high 545 yds). While Utah is 8-1 ATS against conf foes, backing them here with Covid roster questions could be risky against a USC squad that has a double GUB advantage.

COLORADO ST by 17 over UNlv - Since '06 CSU holds an 8-2 SU/ATS record over UNLV. CSU is off 52-21 loss at Boise (315-291 yd edge, Boise 3 blk'd kicks for TDs) while UNLV lost 34-17 at SJSt. UNLV's OFF, led by RB Williams (323, 3.8) & QB Gilliam (534, 6.1%, 4-2) has put up just 308 ypg and the OL has all'd 21 sks in just 4 gms! That OFF faces a CSU DEF that has all'd 396 ypg (290 pass ypg all'd) and have 13 sks in 3 gms! The Rebel pass D (all'd 350 yds vs Nev) faces a strong CSU pass attack that is led by QB O'Brien, and WR Wright & TE McBride are tough matchups. UNLV is just 8-2 ATS the L3Y as a MW AD, while CSU went 2-0 ATS as a MW HF last year.

WKU by 6 over Fiu - LW WKU was off a loss vs an FCS foe but pulled the upset, giving KC Helton his first win as HC. FIU enters off a 38-19 loss to rival FAU. The Panthers allowed the Owls to put up a ssn high 461 yds. WKU held SMiss to 7 pts but still couldn't cover as 8 pt chalk in a 10-7 win LW. The Toppers only avg 276 ypg but FIU is allowing 87 ypg more than their foes avg. The Panthers are 0-4 SU and have 3 straight non-covers but we can't go with the Toppers as chalk when they haven't topped more than 14 pts in any of their last 6 games and are 1-6 as home chalk under Helton.

Rice by 1 over NORTH TEXAS - Rice ended a 3 gm series losing streak LY with a 20-14 outright upset on Sr day. The Owls actually led 20-0 at half with a 228-51 yd edge. Both tms had their gms cancelled LW. This is only Rice's 3rd gm and they've had B2B cancellations. NT has gone over a month without playing (last gm on 10/17). Rice is allowing 73% completions which could be an issue against NT's high powered pass offense. The Mean Green have topped 300 pass yds in every gm. QB Bean threw for 181 & rushed for 169 in their most recent game and WR Darden has topped 200 pass yds in B2B gms. Rice is 8-3 as an AD and NT is on a 6-20 ATS run. We can't help but be concerned about NT going so long without playing a game so Rice gets the edge here.

NORTHWESTERN +7 over Wisconsin

NORTHWESTERN over Wisconsin - NW has been a dog in this series every year since 1989 and are 15-9-1 ATS with 11 outright upsets. LY NW was +24 and held Wisc to 243 yds (205 yds below avg) and was +11 yds but lost 24-15. Wisc enters off a 48-11 (-6') win over a down trodden Mich team. The Badgers got QB Mertz back from quarantine but was still short handed, yet they outgained Mich 468-219. We've backed NW each week this year and it's really paid off. Last week the 'Cats brought us in our 4★ top play on these pages along with a 4★ LPS in their 27-20 (-3) win over Purdue. NW is +53 ypg and their defense is holding foes 124 ypg below their avg! Wisc has been impressive in their 2 wins but they've come against two foes on their way down. We picked up an outright Underdog POW winner a few weeks ago on NW and we can't help but go with the improved Wildcats again. **FORECAST: NORTHWESTERN by 3**

WASHINGTON by 16 over Arizona - The home team is on an 8-3 SU/ATS run in this series although the Huskies (-6') did pick up a 51-27 win LY in Tucson (trailed 17-13 at HT). UW picked up a 6 pt home win against a solid OSU squad (408-252 yd edge). The Wildcats meanwhile nearly pulled off the home upset against the Trojans (USC GW 8 yd TD run w/:25 left).With the Wildcats on just a 3-7 ATS run in P12 play along with failing to cover 13 of their L/18 as an AD, we're backing the Huskies in this one as they've avg'd 469 ypg in the L/5 meetings against UA and have picked up covers in 4 of the L/5 when listed as home chalk.

California by 1 over OREGON ST - The Bears are on a 4-2 SU/ATS run in this series although OSU did pick up the outright upset LY in Berkeley as an 11 pt dog. The Beavers were held to just 252 yds in a 6 pt road loss to UW LW. Cal meanwhile had their gm vs Wash cancelled on Friday and they ply'd at UCLA on Sunday instead, losing 34-10, getting outgained 440-176. The Bears have struggled in the AF role over the L10Y with just a 3-7-1 ATS run. The Beavers meanwhile are just 1-8-1 ATS the L2Y as a HD. OSU has however gone 6-3-1 ATS in P12 play. We can't blame Cal for the poor performance on the road in less than normal circumstances so we think they pull out a win in Corvallis but our lean is with the underdog Beavers.

STANFORD by 1 over Washington St - The Cougs have won 4 in a row in the series by 15 ppg & has covered 5 straight by 13 ppg. In their Pullman matchup LY, WSU (-10) scored 24 unanswered points in the 2H of a 49-22 victory (Stanford all'd 624 yds!). We expected Stanford to get a significant spark with QB Mills back in the lineup after missing the opener due to a false positive and were extremely disappointed in the performance by the Cardinal in their 35-32 loss vs Colo LW and apologies to customers who had our 5★ GOY. WSU meanwhile couldn't take advantage of a DD lead in the 2Q and a 3-0 TD edge in the eventual 14 pt home loss to UO. With Stanford having failed to cover 11 of their L/14 contests coming in and struggling on the defensive end a week ago, we're giving WSU a chance to keep this one tight.

San Jose St by 1 over FRESNO ST - Dating back to 2010 SJSt has gone 6-2-1 ATS in this series & the home team is on a 6-2-1 ATS run. SJSt moved to 4-0 SU/ATS with a win over UNLV while Fresno picked up a win at Utah St & is sitting at 3-1 in the MW! Fresno has put up 467 ypg on OFF led by RB Rivers who is threat on the ground (439, 5.2, 7 td) and as a receiver (18 rec, 227, 2 td), but face a SJSt DEF that is holding foes to 59 ypg under their ssn avg. SJSt got QB Starkel back last wk (274, 2-1) and have put up 407 ypg on OFF & face a FST D that is all'g foes to gain 130 ypg above their ssn avg & are giving up 228 rush ypg (5.2) though SJSt is only rushing for 115 ypg (3.9) this ssn. Fresno is 6-1 ATS the L4Y as a MW dog & SJSt is in a rare role as a MW AF (0-1 ATS under Brennan). Fresno has surprised us this ssn & we think this gm comes down to the wire.

Utah by 15 over SOUTHERN MISS - SM has won the last 3 mtgs and are 2-1 ATS but the home team is 1-2 SU/0-3 ATS. UTSA put up a school record 600 yds vs UTEP LW in a 52-21 (-6) win despite not having RB McCormick who leads CUSA in rushing. DC Nix was put on leave prior to the gm but the DEF performed well w/o him, allowing a ssn low 246. SM held WKU to 10 points but lost by a fg (+8) and was outgained 304-221. It was announced that QB Abraham was OFF prior to the gm. Bkp QB Whatley was unavailable so they went with 3rd string WV Transfer Trey Lowe and he only completed 6-14 for 67 yds. UTSA looked refreshed after finally getting a break from ply'g 9 straight weeks and SM is on a 1-9 ATS run ply'g with their 3rd HC this ssn.

NEBRASKA by 14 over Illinois - Neb is 4-0 SU in this series. LY the Huskers only won 42-38 but had a 674-299 yd edge! IL had td drives of 10, 14, 34 & 37 yds thanks to 4 Neb fumbles. IL was 6 pt dogs LW at Rut but pulled an outright upset, winning 23-20 on a late fg. Isaiah Williams got the start at QB but only threw for 104 (39%). Neb was outgained 501-298 last week vs PSU but pulled out a 30-23 (+3) upset. QB McCaffrey got his first career start and Neb did lead 27-6 at half. The Huskers are putting up 372 ypg and 44 ypg more than their foes allow. IL allows 462 ypg, 74% completions and foes are putting up 98 ypg more than they avg against the IL defense. Neb is only 3-6 as a HF under HC Frost but IL has already suffered 2 blowout defeats. The Illini could get QB Peters back (Covid) but we will take the home Huskers by 2 tds.

SMU by 7 over Houston - Home tm has won the L4 mtgs ATS incl SMU pulling 2 outright upsets at home. SMU is off a 28-24 upset loss vs Tulsa (led 24-7 HT) while Hou took down USF 56-21 (3★ Newsletter winner!). SMU's OFF was kept in check last wk (351 yds) but still is potent & avg'g 507 yds this ssn led by QB Buechele (2781, 65%, 21-4) & RB Bentley (877, 5.6, 11 td) and face a Hou D that gave up 681 yds to UCF & 510 yds to Cin this ssn. Hou was passing for 321 ypg the F/3 gms, but over the L/3 that dropped to 215 ypg, however they ran for 319 yds (8.6) last wk & now face a SMU D that is all'g AAC foes to gain 36 ypg above their ssn avg, but have 8 sks the L/3 gms. SMU is 7-3 ATS the L2Y at home while Hou is 0-3 as a dog this ssn (3-0 ATS as chalk).

ALABAMA by 26 over Kentucky - Bama has won 6 straight over KY but is only 3-3 ATS and the visitor is 6-0 ATS in this series. Bama had their gm vs LSU cancelled LW. KY got QB Wilson back from injury and he sparked the offense to 38 pts but the 'Cats only beat Vandy 38-35 after allowing 2 tds in the last 3:13. Bama is allowing 260 pass ypg but won't have much to worry about against KY who only avg 123 pass ypg and was held under 100 in 4 straight prior to LW. Bama is 3-0 as a HF this year but HC Stoops is 3-1 as a 20+ pt dog and 6-1 as an AD vs ranked foes. The 'Cats have a solid DEF that holds foes 32 ypg below their avg. With KY's lack of pass game, we don't think Bama will have to risk much offensively and with limited possessions due to heavy running we would rather take the points.

OKLAHOMA by 16 over Oklahoma St - Bedlam! Since '03 OU is 15-2 SU/11-5-1ATS, but the home team is just 1-7 ATS the L/8 mtgs. Both teams enter off a bye and both are still in the mix for the Big 12 race. In their L/2 gms before their bye OU put up 540+ yds & 62 pts in both while OSU lost vs Tex (-4 TO's) & barely won at KSt (20-18 win, -114 yds, +2 TO's) in their L/2 gms. OU rF QB Rattler (2018, 68%, 18-6) leads an OU OFF that is putting up 102 ypg more than what their foes allow, but the OSU DEF is holding B12 foes to 75 ypg under their ssn avg. OSU has only avg'd 139 ypg (3.1)

rush the L/2 gms & their OL has given up 8 sks the L/2 gms. OU's DEF has given up 108 rush ypg (3.5) vs B12 foes & has 20 sks the L/4 gms. While OSU is 3-0 ATS the L3Y as a B12 AD, OU seems to be hitting their stride (4-0 SU/ATS win streak) & we'll back the Sooners.

IOWA ST by 16 over Kansas St - Since '08 ISU is just 1-11 SU vs KSt (lone win in '18). Both teams are off a bye & before the bye ISU won their L/2 gms while KSt dropped their L/2 gms after opening B12 play 4-0 SU/ATS. ISU QB Purdy has been up & down (1477.62%, 10-6) but could have a good day vs a KSt pass D that has all'd 300+ yds in 3 gms. ISU RB Hall has been a monster this ssn (1034, 6.3, 13 td) and faces a KSt run D giving up 161 ypg (4.3). KSt's OFF has only put up 316 ypg the L/4 gms since QB Thompson was OFY & have been outgained in all but 2 gms this ssn (-62 ypg) while ISU is +63 ypg. The ISU D is also holding foes to 102 ypg under their ssn avg at home. While KSt is 8-2 ATS as a dog under HC Klieman, they have not been impressive of late & we'll back the more consistent ISU team to get a 2 TD win.

TEXAS A&M by 17 over Ole Miss - A&M is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series. The Aggies were cancelled LW vs Tenn. Ole Miss trailed SCar 42-38 4Q when the Rebels scored 3 unanswered tds and not only won 59-42, but also covered as nearly 2 td chalk. The Rebels put up a ssn high 708 yds but also allowed SCar to put up a ssn high 548 including 318 (7.2) rush. The Aggies OLine has performed as one of the best in the country, rushing for 189 (5.4) and allowing 0 sks in their L/5 gms and only 1 sk on the ssn. Ole Miss has put up the most yds that 6 of their 7 foes have allowed but A&M is holding foes 92 ypg below their avg and held that same SCar tm to a ssn high 3 pts & 150 yds 2 wks ago. Ole Miss is 5-1 as an AD but A&M is 9-5 as a HF and we like the Aggies defensive edge here.

Georgia St by 6 over SOUTH ALABAMA - As ABC foes the series is tied 3-3 SU but GST has won 5 in a row ATS. GST in on the road again (17-13 loss at App) while SALA is off a loss at LA. GST has relied on their run gm again this year, as they are avg'g 205 yds (4.7) led by RB Coates (581, 4.6) & they face a SALA run D that has given up 247 rush ypg (6.4) the L/3 gms. SALA QB Trotter has taken over (1320, 67%, 9-3) and the Jags OFF (avg'g just 289 ypg, 11 ppg the L/3 gms) could get going vs a GST DEF that is all'g SBC foes to gain 40 ypg above their ssn avg. However SALA's OL has given up 17 sks the L/4 gms while GST has 9 sks the L/2 wks. SALA was 4-0 ATS as a HD LY vs SBC foes, but we feel GST has the slightly better team, and will lean with them by nearly a TD.

Texas by 37 over KANSAS - While Tex is 15-1 SU vs KU since '97, the Jayhawks have covered 6 of the L/8 mtgs. Both tms are off a bye but are in 2 totally different places as Tex has won 3 straight gms while KU is 0-7 SU & their lone cover is by 1/2 pt. KU is -234 ypg vs B12 foes and in 4 of their L/5 B12 gms have been outgained by at least 290 yds. While Tex is -34 ypg this season, as they have been up & down this ssn but could use this gm as a "get right" game behind Sr QB Ehlinger, who faces a KU DEF that allows 494 ypg/50 ppg vs B12 foes. While Tex is just 3-5 ATS the L3Y as a B12 AF we cannot lean with KU even as a 4+ TD dog as they are experiencing growing pains this ssn by looking to the future and playing a lot of young players.

TROY by 7 over Middle Tennessee - 2nd mtg this season, as Troy won the 1st mtg 47-14 (26-7 HT lead, 317-216 yd edge) at Middle back in Sept (Troy +255 yds). Troy had their game vs CCar PPD last wk (covid/injury issues) while MT is off a 42-14 (303-520) loss at Marshall. Prior to their last gm vs GSthrn (235 yds/13 pts) the Trojans avg'd 482 yds/35 pts in the previous 4 gms & could get QB Watson (1159, 69%, 10-3) back after he missed the L/2 gms but bkp QB Free has been okay. MT QB O'Hara leads the tm in passing & rushing (515, 3.4) but against Troy he was held to 154 tll yds, but could be more effective here. Troy is just 2-4 ATS as a HF under HC Lindsey & often times the team that loses the 1st mtg plays better the 2nd time, which is what we expect here.

AUBURN by 7 over Tennessee - In '18 Tenn entered 2-3 while Aub was 4-2 coming in but the Vols pulled an outright upset as DD road dogs, ending an 11 gm SEC losing streak. This time the Vols enter 2-4 while Aub is 4-2. Both tms had their gms cancelled last week. Aub is +14 ypg while Tenn is -90 ypg. Tenn actually led Ark 13-0 at half in their last gm but lost QB Guarantano in 1st poss of 2H and never scored again. Aub has topped 200 rush in each of their L/4 while Tenn has held their L/4 foes under 200 rush yds. QB Nix is 9-1 SU/7-3 ATS at home and hits 63% w/a 14-0 ratio but the Tigers are only 5-11 as a HF while Tenn is 6-3 as an AD and if Guarantano plays they should keep this within a touchdown.

LOUISIANA TECH by 23 over ULM - Tms have met 42 times (last met in 2000, LT won 42-19) with LT holding a 29-13 lead. ULM had their last game PPD vs Ark St while LT has had their L/2 gms PPD (covid) and have not played since Oct 31 when they upset UAB 37-34. ULM is only putting up 311 ypg on OFF and face a solid LT DEF holding foes to 5 ypg below ssn avg. The ULM DEF is a different story, as they are giving up 61 ypg above what their foes avg & the LT OFF (avg'g 334 tll ypg & 92 rush ypg) could have a big game on the ground vs a ULM run D all'g 249 ypg (5.4). We will back LT here by nearly 3 tds as it is impossible to trust ULM as they are 2-9 ATS the L3Y vs non-conf foes.

Arkansas St by 10 over TEXAS ST - Ark St has gone 6-1 SU vs TXSt as SBC foes, and have covered the L/2 gms by an avg of nearly 2 TD's. Ark St had their gm last week PPD while TXSt is off a game vs GSthrn. Ark St avg's 338 pass yds vs SBC foes led by QB's Hatcher/Bonner (2624, 60%, 23-7) & the OFF is avg'g 66 more ypg than SBC foes allow. That pass attack faces a TXSt pass D that is all'g 253 ypg (68% comp) vs SBC foes & are giving up 83 ypg more than what their foes avg. While TXSt is avg'g 360 yds vs SBC foes, they have an improved run gm (140, 4.2) and do face an Ark St D that is all'g 103 ypg above what their foes avg. TXSt is just 1-4 ATS under Spavital as a single-digit SBC dog while Ark St is 8-5 ATS the L4Y as single-digit SBC chalk.

4★ CLEVELAND over Philadelphia - After a rough 10 pt road loss against the rival Giants, the Eagles are back on the road for a 2nd consec wk to take on a CLE squad that picked up a narrow 3 pt win in windy conditions over HOU following their bye wk (356-243 yd edge). The Eagles have yet to lose to the Browns since their return to the NFL back in '99 as they own a 5-0 series lead (2-3 ATS) with a 11 pt avg MOV (29-10 home win in '16). While PHI has covered 8 of their L/12 as a NDIV AD, a win here by the Browns (4-1 SU TY at home) would put them in excellent position for the early AFC playoff picture. **FORECAST: CLEVELAND by 12**

3★ MINNESOTA over Dallas - Following a MNF trip to Soldier Field against the Bears where they attempted to win their 3rd consecutive game since coming off of bye, the Vikings get 3 straight home matchups with a chance to get right back into the NFC Playoff picture. The Cowboys meanwhile return from their bye (3-1 ATS after a week off) with road trips in 3 of their next 4 contests. In their "Lone Star" matchup a season ago, the Vikings (+3) picked up the 28-24 victory despite a 443-364 yd disadvantage. With DAL failing to cover 8 of their 9 contests so far TY and having their annual Thanksgiving home game on deck, we're backing the Vikings here as they've covered 5 of their L/6 as of presstime. **FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 13**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Cincinnati over WASHINGTON - Following a final second loss to the Lions in a game that they trailed 24-3 late in the 4Q (QB Smith 38-55-390-0-0 in 1st start in 2 yrs), WAS returns to FedEx Field for their only HG in a 5-wk span to take on a Bengals squad who was held to just 10 pts in a 26 pt loss inside of Heinz Field against the Steelers. In their last meeting back in '16, CIN (-3) and WAS finished in a 27-27 tie in a game that WAS owned a 546-415 yd edge in. Prior to that matchup, the Bengals had won and covered 3 straight with a 7 pt avg MOV. With WAS covering just 1 of their L/5 against AFC foes coming in (only ATS win came by a half point earlier TY vs BAL) and having a Thanksgiving trip to DAL on deck, we're calling for the Bengals to get the victory here as they're on a solid 7-2-1 ATS run with the only spread defeats coming at BAL and LW at PIT. **FORECAST: Cincinnati by 6**

OTHER PLAYS

Arizona at SEATTLE - Thursday - Only HG in a 4-wk span for the Seahawks who have now dropped 3 of their L/4 following a 7 pt defeat LW against the Rams where QB Wilson struggled with just 249 pass yds & 3 TO's. The Cardinals meanwhile pulled out a miracle win in the desert with QB Murray connecting with WR Hopkins on a 43 yd Hail Mary TD w/:02 left (32-30 win over BUF). In their 1st meeting a month ago in Glendale, the Cardinals covered for a 5th time in 6 matchups against the Seahawks in a 37-34 OT victory (ARZ 10 pts in last 2:28 of the 4Q). While ARZ is 7-2-1 ATS as an AD, a win here by SEA would put them in good shape in the NFC West with their next 4 opponents having a combined 8-28-1 record for 2020. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

NEW ORLEANS by 3 over Atlanta - First of 2 matchups between the Falcons and Saints in a 3-week span as NO heads to ATL for Wk 13. The Falcons are well-rested following their bye week (3-1 SU/ATS since interim HC Morris took over) while the Saints picked up a 14 pt win over the 49ers LW in the Superdome despite being without QB Brees for the entire 2H (rib inj, CS here). The Saints have won and covered 3 of the L/4 in the series including a 26-18 (-7) win in the most recent battle back in Wk 13 a year ago. While NO has also covered 6 of their L/9 inside the NFC South, giving too many points to a hot Falcons team could be risky.

Detroit by 4 over CAROLINA - After a rough 2-game losing skid to IND and MIN where they were outscored by 17 ppg, the Lions got back into the win column LW at home against WAS with a GW 59-yd FG as time expired (WAS 34-21 FD & 464-372 yd edges). The Panthers meanwhile dropped a 5th straight matchup a week ago at home against the Bucs who held CAR to just 187 yds in a 23 pt win. While the Panthers have won 6 of the L/8 in this series (3-4-1 ATS), the Lions came out victorious in their last meeting back in '18 as a 4 pt dog (CAR 387-309 yd edge). Although the Lions are on just a 4-12-2 ATS run coming in, CAR has covered just 3 of their L/14 at home and could be without QB Bridgewater here after a late knee inj vs TB.

New England by 1 over HOUSTON - This marks the only HG in a 4-week span for the Texans who return to action following a 3 pt loss in CLE where they were held to just 7 pts and 243 yds. NE meanwhile picked up a 6 pt home win (+7) in rainy and windy conditions against the Ravens despite being outgained 357-308. In their Wk 13 battle a season ago, the Texans (+3) picked up their 1st win against the Patriots since '09 as NE had won the prior 6 matchups by 15 ppg. While the Patriots had gone 7-2 ATS as a NDIV AD heading into 2020, they have failed to cover both attempts TY against SEA & KC. With HOU having failed to cover 6 of their L/8 as a HF, we're taking the points in this one.

Pittsburgh by 7 over JACKSONVILLE - Following a 26 pt victory a week ago in Heinz Field against the Bengals to remain undefeated on the season (QB Roethlisberger 333 pass yds & 4 TD's), the Steelers head South to take on a Jaguars squad that dropped a close contest in Lambeau against the Packers (4 pt loss as 13' pt dog, GB 395-260 yd edge). After earning the 2-game sweep in '17 highlighted by a 45-42 victory in the AFC DIV Rnd, the Jaguars (+4.5) fell 20-16 at home in '17 with PIT getting the GW 1-yd QB sneak by Big Ben with :05 left. While JAX has gone just 8-20 ATS as a NDIV HD, they've shown some fight the last 2 wks with rookie QB Luten under center covering vs HOU and GB. With the Steelers also having a key Thanksgiving night home matchup against BAL on deck, we'll take the points in this one.

INDIANAPOLIS by 7 over Green Bay - Following a Thur night matchup against AFC rival TEN where they picked up a 17 pt win with a 430-294 yd edge, the Colts return home to take on a Packers squad that had a closer than expected 4 pt win at home against the Jags (4 pt win, 395-260 yd edge). In their most recent matchup back in '16, the Packers (-7) dropped a 31-26 contest at home despite a 405-355 yd edge (IND 99-yd KR TD on 1st play). BALTIMORE by 8 over Tennessee - Revenge time for the Ravens after they were held to a ssn-low 12 pts in their DIV Rnd loss to the Titans a year ago as 9.5 pt chalk (BAL 29-15 FD & 530-300 yd edges but -3 TO's). The Titans head to BAL with some extra rest following a rough 17 pt defeat in Nashville last Thur against the Colts (IND 430-294 yd edge). The Ravens meanwhile are home for the only time in a 4-week span following a tough 6 pt loss in NE where they finished with a 357-308 yd edge. While BAL does have a key Thanksgiving night trip to PIT up next, their 13-6 ATS run coming in along with LY's postseason failure should have them motivated here.

Kansas City at LAS VEGAS - SNF - Following an easy 25 pt win LW at home against the Broncos where we picked up a 4★ Newsletter Victory, the Raiders are right back inside of Allegiant Stadium to take on a well-rested Chiefs squad who has gone 23-8 ATS as an AF. In their trip to Arrowhead earlier this year, the Raiders (+11) picked up a surprising 40-32 outright upset of the Chiefs behind a 347 yd, 3 TD effort from QB Carr. Despite that victory, keep in mind that the Raiders have won just 2 of the L/11 overall meetings dating back to '15. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!
