KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Northwestern over MICHIGAN ST - The visitor is on a 13-4 SU/15-2 ATS run in this series and NW is 3-1 SU/ATS. The 'Cats have been our cover stars this ssn, going 5-0 ATS and we picked up our 2nd outright Underdog POW winner on NW last week in their 17-7 (+7) win over Wisc (also 3★ LPS winner)! MSU had their gm vs MD cancelled LW. We went against Mich St the 2 weeks prior, winning 4★ LPS on both. The Spartans scored 7 pts & put up 239 ypg in those. NW is allowing 315 ypg, have held 4 of 5 foes to their ssn low yards and are holding foes 122 ypg below their avg. We can't help but continue to ride the Wildcats especially against MSU who is 1-14 ATS at home while NW is 19-6 ATS on the road and have covered all 5 gms TY! **FORECAST: Northwestern by 24**

3★ Nevada over HAWAII - 25th mtg. Since '12 Nev is 6-2 SU/ATS in this series. Nev is off a big win vs SDSU (3★ PS Winner!) as they put up 133 yds above what SDSU was all g. Nev's OFF is led by QB Strong (1805, 70%, 14-2) and RB Taoua (307, 5.9) could have a big game here vs a UH DEF that is all g 227 rush ypg (5.1). UH has done well vs poor DEF's (528 ypg/37 ppg vs Fresno,NMEx) but struggled with good DEF's (301 ypg/16 ppg vs WY,SDSU,Boise) and face a Nev DEF giving up just 313 ypg. While Nev is just 1-3 ATS as a MW AF under HC Norvell, UH is 1-5-1 ATS the L4Y as a MW HD, and we think the Pack continue their winning ways with a convincing road win. **FORECAST: NEVADA by 17**

3★ UAB over Southern Miss - UAB is 7-2 SU and the home team is 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS in this series. The Blazers were w/o their starting QB and RB Brown LY and put up just 173 yds in a 37-2 (+7) loss. UAB hasn't ply'd since their 10/31 loss at LA Tech. SMiss has lost their L/4 vs FBS foes with their L/2 coming by a fg each. They did give up 233 (5.0) rushing to UTSA LW and UAB avg 207 (5.2) rush ypg with RB Brown leading the way with 740 (4.7). UAB is +70 ypg while SM is -54. The Golden Eagles got bkp QB Whitley back LW and he threw for 272 yds. We can't go against UAB in Legion Field where they've gone 2-1 SU/15-5-2 ATS and we think this is a cheap line against a Golden Eagles team that has 3 losses this year of 24 pts or more. **FORECAST: UAB by 27**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Georgia over SOUTH CAROLINA - UGA has won 4 of the L/5 in this series but are out for revenge after losing 20-17 (OT) LY as 21' pt chalk. DB Mukuamu had 3 ints including a pick 6 for SC LY but he opted out LW along with their best CB Jaycee Horn after HC Muschamp was fired. The 'Cocks trailed 17-0 (+6) but only lost by a td. HC Smart probably wishes he turned to JT Daniels sooner after he threw for 401 last week vs Miss St but the Dawgs only won 31-24 (-25). UGA is +39 ypg and hold foes 67 ypg below their avg. SC is -88 ypg and their offense puts up 83 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. SC has lost 4 straight by 24 ypg and we think UGA will get their revenge by more than 3 tds against a depleted SC team that is 3-7 as a HD. **FORECAST: Georgia by 27**

2★ Penn St over MICHIGAN - PSU enters 0-5 despite being +58 ypg. The Nittany Lions have lost the TO battle in every gm and LW was -3 TO's in a 41-21 (+1) loss. Mich needed 3 OT's to dispatch Rutgers 48-42 (-12). New starting QB McNamara did throw for 260 and 4 td's. Mich is -36 ypg and was outgained by 103 yds in a 17 pt loss at Indiana. PSU outgained the Hoosiers by 277 yds in their OT loss. The Nittany Lions are holding foes 78 ypg below their avg while Mich is all g 76 ypg more than their foes avg. It looks to us that PSU is an unfortunate team that is better than their record while just hasn't been very good so we'll go with the dog by just under a td. **FORECAST: Penn St by 6**

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 26TH

Colorado St at AIR FORCE - Battle for the Ram-Falcon trophy. Since '06 AF has gone 12-2 SU vs CSU. CSU had their game vs UNLV canceled last wk while AF won last Fri vs NMEx 28-0. Despite AF starting the ssn with just over 60 ply's on the roster they are 2-2 & are avg'g 337 rush yds (5.8), but do face a CSU run D that has all'd just 106 ypg (2.5). CSU is a pass-first team with QB O'Brien, WR Wright & TE McBride & they face an AF pass D that has all'd 220 ypg (69% comp all'd) vs MW foes. AF was 3-1 ATS as home chalk vs MW foes in ssn ago, but CSU comes into this gm rested and the road tm is on a 4-0 ATS run in this series. New Mexico at UTAH ST - As MW foes USU is 5-2 SU vs NMEx and have won the L/3 gms ATS. USU is in the middle of a forgetful ssn (0-4 SU/ATS) as they fired HC Andersen & QB Shelley was dismissed. USU had their gm canceled last wk while NMEx lost 28-0 at AF. USU's OFF is avg'g just 243 yds & 11 pts while their DEF is all g 526 ypg & is all g foes to gain 116 ypg above their avg. They face an 0-4 NMEx team (2-2 ATS) but the Lobos are avg'g 400 yps on OFF and QB Hall has played well for the inj'd Tuotiio the L/2 gms. But NMEx's DEF is giving up 474 ypg & are all g foes to gain 77 ypg above their ssn avg. NMEx is a MW favorite for first time since 2017 & USU is on a 1-6 ATS slide the L2Y as a MW dog.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 27TH

Ucf by 31 over USF - The War on 1-4! UCF has won SU/ATS the L/2 games incl a 34-7 win LY (539-250, +3 TO's). UCF is off a 36-33 loss vs Cincy while USF's gm was PPD. USF's DEF is all g 479 ypg/43 ppg the L/4 gms & take on a UCF OFF that despite gaining "just" 359 vs Cincy, are avg'g 587 yds/43 pts & are putting up 192 ypg above what their foes allow. UCF's D isn't great (452 ypg) but USF's OFF is getting held to 89 ypg under what their foes allow. Against 6 common AAC foes USF is -111 ypg/-18 ppg while UCF is +90 ypg/+10 ppg. While UCF is just 2-5 ATS the L2Y as an AAC AF, USF is 0-2-1 ATS the L2Y as a dog of 20+ pts & we'll back UCF who is off a tough loss & could be looking to take their frustration out on their rivals who are still looking for their 1st FBS win.

Notre Dame by 10 over NORTH CAROLINA - ND is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series, and the visitor is 4-0 ATS. A win for ND almost guarantees a trip to ACC Title gm. Both tms are fresh off byes. Matchup of 2 red hot QB's. Sam Howell has completed 73% w/a 13-1 ratio in his L/3. Ian Book has completed 62% w/a 8-0 ratio with 235 (4.7) rush in his L/4. Two NC RB's have topped 800 yds this ssn but ND has held their L/5 foes to just 69 rush ypg including holding Clemson's Etienne to 18-28! The Irish are holding foes 107 ypg below their avg and held 3 foes to their ssn low. NC is allowing 30 ypg more than their foes avg and let WF put up a ssn high 606 yds in their last gm! ND is 9-4 as an AF and while the offenses appear pretty even, the Irish have a HUGE defensive edge and get the call here.

Stanford by 6 over CALIFORNIA - This is the 123rd mtg of the "Big Game". The Cardinal saw their 9-gm series winning streak snapped LY on "The Farm" as the Bears (+1) got a 16-yd TD w/1:19 left for the 24-20 victory (Cal 22-15 FD & 424-351 yd edges). The Bears dropped a back-and-forth contest LW in Corvallis (OSU GW TD w/4:30 left, Cal 439-360 yd edge). Stanford meanwhile saw their game against WSU canceled (Covid). While the Cardinal are on a 0-5-1 ATS run in P12 AG's the L2Y, the Bears have struggled as home chalk with a 0-7-1 ATS mark. With Stanford covering 7 of the L/10 battles for the Axe, we'll call for them to sneak out a win here.

Oregon by 17 over OREGON ST - 124th meeting in the "Civil War" rivalry. Since '08 the Ducks are 11-1 SU/7-5 ATS including a 55-15 drubbing of the Beavers in their last trip to Corvallis in '18. OSU (+19') did pick up the cover a year ago however finishing with narrow FD and yardage edges in a 14 pt defeat. The Beavers picked up a narrow 4 pt win at home vs Cal despite a 439-360 yd disadvantage. The Ducks meanwhile were fortunate to knock off a short-handed Bruins squad despite UCLA finishing with a 462-422 yd edge (UO +3 TO's). While the Beavers are on a 7-3-1 ATS run inside of the P12, they have gone just 1-9-1 ATS as a HD. With the Ducks covering 6 of their L/8 as an AF, we have no issue backing the visitor in this one.

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Iowa St by 4 over TEXAS - LY ISU beat Tex for only the 3rd time, but Tex has covered the L/4. ISU is off of a game vs KSt while Tex's last game vs Kan was PPD. ISU QB Purdy (1713, 64%, 13-6) has had an up & down ssn, but faces a Tex pass D that is all g 308 yds (69% comp all'd) over the L/4 gms. While Tex has all'd 131 rush ypg (3.5) vs B12 foes, they face ISU RB Hall who leads the FBS in rushing (1169, 6.5, 15 td). Tex's OFF is gaining 44 ypg above what their B12 foes allow but face an ISU DEF all g 297 ypg the L/5 gms. Against 5 common B12 foes ISU is +19 ypg (2-1-2 ATS) while Tex is -41 ypg (2-3 ATS). Tex is just 3-10 ATS as a B12 HF under Herman while ISU is 16-6-1 ATS as a B12 dog under HC Campbell & we'll back the Cyclones to pull another upset.

IOWA by 17 over Nebraska - Iowa has won 5 straight series mtgs but Neb has covered the L/2, losing both by a fg. The Hawkeyes have won 3 straight by 30 ppg and have had the yards edge in all 5 gms this year. They enter off a 20 pt win over PSU although they did only hold a +19 yd edge. Neb has been outgained in 3 of their 4 gms and enter off a surprising 18 pt home loss to IL. The Huskers may be turning back to Adrian Martinez this week after LW's starter, Luke McCaffrey had 4 TO's and was benched late. Iowa is +53 ypg and holds foes 72 ypg below their avg. Neb is -74 ypg and is allowing their foes to put up 41 ypg more than their avg. At 1-3, Neb is desperate for a win but they are 1-6 as an AD while Iowa is 9-5 as a HF and the Hawkeyes just dispatched a desperate PSU team.

Wyoming by 17 over UNLV - 25th mtg with WY holding a 13-11 SU lead, but since '09 WY is on a 5-2 SU/ATS run incl a 53-17 win LY at home. WY has not played s/ Nov 7 when they lost at CSU, while UNLV had their last gm canceled. WY's OFF is led by RB Valladay (397, 4.8) but QB Williams did have 321 pass yds vs CSU & they face a UNLV DEF giving up 466 ypg (213 rush ypg, 6.2 ypc all'd). The UNLV OFF has struggled only putting up 308 ypg & in their last gm QB's Gilliam & Rogers split reps. After giving up 496 yds to Nev, the WY DEF has given up 288 ypg the L/2 gms. The WY pass rush has 11 sks in 3 gms & faces a UNLV OL that has all'd 21 sks in 4 gms! While WY is 0-2 ATS as a MW AF this ssn, UNLV is on a 3-9 ATS slide the L2Y as a MW dog.

Central Michigan by 4 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - 98th mtg (MAC's most). CM is 8-3 SU & ATS vs EM but HT has won 5 str SU (3-2 ATS) & the dog has covered 5 str (3 outright upsets). CM started 2-0 SU & ATS & LW led rival WM 14-0. CM fell behind 31-14 at HT & 52-30 4Q before scoring 14 late to lose 52-44 (even). EM is 0-3 SU. They were 2-0 ATS heading into LW, but ran into Toledo, that had a 4Q collapse the week before. EM trailed 45-13 4Q as a 6' pt HD before scoring the L/15 incl a td :12 left. Both were outgained 200+ yds LW with both having 2 late drives that accounted for 139+ of their total yds. CM must win to keep their slim hopes 2 straight trips to the MAC Chmp gm but EM is 23-5-1 ATS as a dog s/16 & we look for them to keep it close.

LIBERTY by 35 over UMass - These tms split 2 meetings with UMass winning by a fg in '18 & Lib winning by 42 in '19. Both prior mtgs were in Amherst. Lib had a shot to beat their 3rd ACC foe this ssn LW at NCSt but had their GW fg blk'd. UMass ply'd just their 3rd gm of the ssn LW and covered their 2nd straight by losing 24-2 (+33') at FAU. The Minutemen have yet to put up 200 yards in a gm & only avg 176 ypg. Lib was held to a ssn low 279 yds LW but also held NCSt to a ssn low 321 yds. Lib no longer has a chance to finish undefeated and they've got a big gm vs Coastal Carolina on deck so we don't expect their best effort while UMass gets to play B2B wks for the first time this ssn.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 28TH

Tcu by 31 over KANSAS - As B12 foes TCU is 7-1 SU but KU holds a 6-2 ATS record. TCU is off a bye while KU had their gm vs Tex PPD. After putting up 450+ yds & 33+ pts in the F/2 B12 gms TCU has avg'd 343 yds & 20 pts the L/5 gms, but can have a "get right" game as they face a KU DEF all g 504 ypg & 52 ppg the L/4 gms. TCU has another solid DEF unit TY and are holding B12 foes to 50 ypg under their ssn avg & KU's OFF is avg'g just 231 yds & 14 pts and are -291 ypg the L/5 gms. While TCU is just 1-4 ATS the L3Y as a B12 AF, Kan is just 1-5 this ssn as a DD B12 dog & that lone cover is by a 1/2 pt so we don't mind backing TCU here as a big favorite.

Georgia Southern by 6 over GEORGIA ST - Rivalry is known as "Modern Day Hate" and GS has won the L/2 mtgs both SU/ATS. GSthrn is off a 28-27 loss vs Army where QB Werts left with an inj (status ?) while this is (as of now) the ssn finale for GS. The GSthrn option has not skipped a beat despite losing top RB King (OFY ACL) as they are avg'g 321 yds (5.5) the L/3 SBC gms & face a GS run D that despite all g 121 ypg (3.4) for the ssn, have all'd 207 rush ypg (4.8) to LA, CCar, App St. GS's OFF is led by their run game (207 ypg, 4.7) but face a GSthrn run D that is all g just 83 ypg (3.3) vs SBC foes. Against 5 common SBC foes GSthrn is +9 ypg & GS is -56 ypg. Behind GSthrn's strong run gm & stingy run D, we will back the Eagles in what we think will be a close gm.

Arkansas by 3 over MISSOURI - MO is 4-0 SU vs rival Ark. The home team is 6-0 ATS with MO winning the last 3 SU/ATS in Columbia. Ark has now lost B2B gms and we went against the Hogs for a 3★ winner on these pages in their 27-24 (-1) loss to LSU. MO was -6 LW against a SCar tm that just fired their HC and had 3 starters opt out on DEF. The Tigers led 17-0 at half and despite getting shutout in the 2H held on for a 7 pt win. Ark is -63 ypg on the road while MO is +97 ypg at home despite one of their home gms coming against Bama. Ark has the edge on offense but MO has the edge on defense & ST's. The Hogs are 3-1 as an AD while MO is 3-0 ATS at home. Tough call but we'll give a 3 pt edge to Arkansas who is 6-2 ATS on the ssn.

FLORIDA by 27 over Kentucky - This series has been dominated by FL who has won 32 of the L/33 mtgs but KY's only win during that span was LTH and the 'Cats have covered 3 straight mtgs. LW we dropped our Totals GOM on FL vs Vandy Over 69'. There were 992 ttl yds but the tms managed just 55 pts. FL put up 586 yds but managed just 38 pts and only won by 21. KY was no match for Bama LW in a 63-3 (+32) loss. The 'Cats avg just 301 ypg and is -135 ypg on the road. FL is +112 ypg and +140 ypg at home. The Gators are putting up 121 ypg more than their foes allow while KY avg 125 ypg less than their foes allow. The 'Cats have been held to 10 pts or less in 3 of their L/4 gms and FL is 7-1 as a HF so we've got the Gators by nearly 4 tds.

Smu by 14 over EAST CAROLINA - Since '05 the series is 4-4 SU/ATS, but the home team has failed to cover the L/5 gms. SMU had their gm last wk vs Hou PPD while ECU won 28-3 at Temp (3★ LP winner!). ECU's DEF comes in all g 455 ypg & are all g foes to gain 50 ypg above their ssn avg. SMU's OFF led by QB Buechele (2781, 65%, 21-4) is putting up 507 ypg (318 pass ypg) and faces an ECU pass D all g 267 pass ypg (65% comp all'd) to non-option teams. The SMU DEF has held their own at times this ssn (444 ypg/32 ppg vs AAC foes) but faces an ECU OFF that is avg'g 396 ypg/24 ppg the L/4 gms. While SMU is just 3-6 ATS as an AF under HC Dykes, ECU is 1-2 ATS this ssn as a HD & we think SMU exploits their weak pass D & wins by 2 TD's.

WISCONSIN by 24 over Minnesota - UW is 15-1 SU but the visitor is 4-2 SU/5-0-1 ATS and the Gophers 1 win was LTH in '18. Minn benefitted from a bad PI call LW and held on to beat Pur 38-31 (+1) but were out'd 492-394. We went against the Badgers for our Underdog POW as well as a 3★ LPS. UW was 7' pt chalk at NW but never led and lost by 10! The Gophers are -51 ypg while the Badgers come in +188 ypg. RB Ibrahim has topped 100 in all 5 gms but UW is holding foes to 67 (3.0) rush ypg. QB Morgan completed 66% w/a 30-7 ratio LY but he's fallen to just 56% w/a 4-4 ratio in 5 gms. Wisc is only allowing 48% completions this year. Wisc is 6-3-1 as DD chalk while HC Fleck is 3-6-1 as an AD. We've got the Badgers taking home Paul Bunyan's Axe by more than 3 tds.

Wku by 1 over CHARLOTTE - The home team is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series. WKU had been held to 14 pts or less in 6 straight gms entering LW but put up 38 pts against FIU. Their offense didn't show significant improvement though considering they only put up 278 yds with 2 td's coming their defense. UC has had 5 gms ppd while WKU is the only CUSA tm that hasn't had a ppd game. The 49ers are -25 ypg but +52 ypg vs CUSA foes. WKU has one of the nation's most underrated DEF's, holding foes 53 ypg below their avg and have held 4 of their L/5 foes under 275 yds and also held BYU to a ssn low 410 yds. WKU is 9-4-1 as an AD while UC is 1-3 as a HF. The 'Toppers have a big edge on defense so we will call for a small upset.

Cincinnati by 38 over TEMPLE - LY Cincy snapped a 4 gm SU losing streak to Temp, but Cincy has failed to cover 5 straight vs Temp. Cincy 36-33 at UCF (held UCF to 260 ypg below ssn avg) while Temp lost 28-3 vs ECU. Temp's OFF is avg'g just 279 yds/11 pts the L/4 gms & started a true frosh walk-on QB last wk (QB Russo's status unknown) and now face a Cincy DEF that is holding AAC foes to 180 ypg under their ssn avg. Temp's DEF is allowing 482 ypg/38 ppg the L/5 gms & faces a Cincy OFF putting up 519 ypg/44 ppg the L/5 gms. Against AAC foes Cincy is 5-1-1 ATS this ssn & Temple sits at just 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS this ssn & with nothing to play for we think Cincy rolls even as 5+TD chalk as they need to keep stacking up big wins to impress the Playoff Committee.

Virginia by 7 over FLORIDA ST - UVA is favored in Tallahassee for the first time ever! UVA is 2-1 SU/ATS in this series and won LTH. UVA enters fresh off an easy win over FCS Abilene Christian. FSU was ready to host Clemson last week but was actually cancelled on gameday. The 'Noles started true frosh Chubba Purdy in their last gm but he was ruled OFY due to a lingering shoulder inj so they are going back to Jordan Travis who started when they upset NCar. FSU is -127 ypg vs ACC foes while UVA is -48 but also -92 ypg in their L/4 vs ACC foes. UVA is holding foes to 154 (3.9) rush ypg but starting DT Briggs left the team and they've got depth issues on the Dline. FSU has all kinds of issues but UVA is in a rare spot favored here and we've only got the 'Hoos by a td.

Louisiana Tech by 6 over FIU - LT is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS in this series. The Bulldogs haven't ply'd since their upset win at UAB on 10/31 with their L/3 gms cancelled. FIU was off B2B cancellations LW and lost 38-21 (+7). The Panthers held a 17-13 FD edge but their last td came with just 18 left and they also had a 100 yd KR td. LT had 3 starters on offense opt out last week including RB Henderson & WR Hardy. FIU lost multiple starters due to injury including All-CUSA OL Demery. It's hard to make a pick with both tms so depleted but LT does have the edge on DEF so we'll lean with the Bulldogs.

Nc State by 20 over SYRACUSE - NCSt is 5-1 SU in this series and won LY 16-10 (-4) in Bailey Hockman's first start at QB. The Wolfpack have won 3 straight after squeaking out a 15-14 (-4) win over Liberty LW. We won our Friday Night Marquee (just \$12, call 1-800-654-3448) going against Cuse LW in a 30-0 (+19) loss at L'ville. QB Morgan finished with just 40 pass yds and the Orange were outgained 413-137 & out FD'd 26-7! Cuse is avg just 250 ypg and have been held to just 27 pts in their L/3 gms and they are putting up 151 ypg less than their foes allow. NCSt is -111 ypg on the road but Cuse is -209 ypg at home so we'll lay the points with the Wolfpack who are 6-2 ATS this ssn.

Duke by 3 over GEORGIA TECH - Duke is 5-1 SU/6-0 ATS in this series but most of their success came because HC Cloutier was excellent at defending GT's triple option. This is a battle of QB's who struggle with TO's. Duke's Brice has 12 int's and has at least 1 int in all but 1 ACC game. GT's Sims has 10 int's but he only has 2 in his last 4 games. Both tms have had B2B gms cancelled. GT is -98 ypg and have 5 losses by 17+ pts. Duke is only -5 ypg and they've suffered 4 losses by double-digits. RB's Durant & Jackson both have over 580 rush yds and GT is allowing 203 (4.7) rush ypg. Both teams are turnover prone so it's hard to lean either way but we will give Duke a 3 point edge against a Jackets team that is only 2-8 ATS at home while Duke is 8-3 if an AF.

Oklahoma by 17 over WEST VIRGINIA - OU is 8-0 SU vs WVU & have gone 5-0-1 ATS over the L/6 mtgs. OU is off a 41-13 win vs rival Oka St (Top Play 4★ LP winner!) while WV is off a bye. The OU OFF is avg'g 512 yds & 50 pts the L/5 gms incl running for 201 ypg the L/3 gms since RB Stevenson (332.6.6) ret'd, but the WV DEF is all'g B12 foes to 284 ypg & holding them to 89 ypg under their ssn avg. WV's OFF (417 ypg this ssn) has avg'd just 376 yds & 19 pts their L/2 gms & face an OU DEF that is all'g just 311 ypg/16 ppg (18 sks) the L/4 gms. Against 6 common B12 foes OU is +233 ypg while WVU is just +7 ppg. While OU was 3-7-1 ATS the L/3Y as a B12 AF, they are 2-1 in that role this ssn & WV is just -1-4 ATS the L/2Y as a B12 HD & we'll back the red-hot Sooners again!

INDIANA by 16 over Maryland - IU is 1-4 SU/2-3 ATS in this series but the home team is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS. The Hoosiers gave OSU everything they could handle as nearly 3 td dogs, only losing 42-35. MD had their 2nd straight gm cancelled LW and could be short-handed due to Covid. The Hoosiers are +9 ypg and holding foes 39 ypg below their avg. QB Penix (14-4 ratio) will try to take advantage of a MD defense that allows 474 ypg and 110 ypg more than their foes avg. QB Tagovailoa was impressive in B2B upsets over Minn & PSU but faces an IU DEF that has 10 int's including 3 off Justin Fields LW. Indiana is 5-0 ATS on the ssn and HC Allen is 11-1 as a HF while MD is 2-7 as an AD.

PURDUE by 8 over Rutgers - Rut won the only prior Big 10 mtg back in '17. The Scarlet Knights nearly upset Mich as 12 pt dogs, losing 48-42 in 3 OT's. Pur is trying to rebound a questionable PI call erased their go ahead td in last Friday's 34-31 (-1) loss at Minn. Rut is -74 ypg while Pur is only -5 ypg and WR Moore was a surprise return LW and had 116 yds. Pur avg 18 ypg more than their foes allow. Rut avg 64 ypg less than their foes allow but did put up the most yds Mich has allowed this ssn LW. Pur is 1-5 as a HF and Rut is already 2-0 as a road dog including an outright upset win over Mich St and they kept it closer than expected vs OSU.

BUFFALO by 6 over Kent St - Could decide the MAC East Title. LY Kent St pulled a 30-27 upset as a 5' pt HD. Both are 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS. Kent St only led rival Akron 35-28 at HT but pulled away for a 69-35 win as a 26' pt HF. Flashes are led by QB Dustin Crum is avg 279 ypg pass with a 9-1 ratio while adding 164 rush (5.3) & 3 td. LW Buffalo led BG 35-3 into 4Q as a 31 pt AF but failed to cover only winning 42-17. Bulls only had a 23-22 fd & a 470-399 yd edge despite RB Patterson rushing for 301 (9.7) & 4 td's. Kent St beat BG the week prior 62-24 as a 20' pt AF finishing with a 34-16 fd & a 667-365 yd edge. Buffalo is the media's pick to win the MAC East & opened as an almost DD fav. We will take the Flashes plus the pts & would not be surprised by an outright upset.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 24 over Northern Illinois - LY in the regular ssn finale WM only needed to win as a 9 pt AF to make the MAC Championship game but NIU never trailed & pulled the outright upset 17-14. This year the teams came into the game at opposite ends. WM is 3-0 SU & ATS including wins over the other top 2 in the MAC West in Toledo & CM. NIU comes in 0-3 SU & 1-2 ATS but did cover LW as a 14' pt AD. The Huskies led Ball St 14-7 late 2Q & down 9, hit a fg w/44 left but failed to recover the onside. WM trailed rival CM 14-0 early 1Q but led 31-14 at HT & 52-30 mid-4Q, holding on to give us a Wed Night Marquee winner 52-44 (even). We look for Broncos to extract some revenge for LY's loss here to take a firm grasp on the MAC West Crown.

TOLEDO by 12 over Ball St - After letting WM make a miracle comeback the wk prior, Toledo took no chances LW vs EM as they led 45-13 mid 4Q as a 6' AF before allowing 2 td's, (last w/:12). UT had 26-18 fd & 489-277 yd edges. The weak prior Ball St trailed EM 21-7 early 2Q & needed a td w/06 left to get by EM 38-31 as a 9' pt HF. They had a 30-22 fd edge but only a 536-477 yd edge. LW the Cardinals struggled with a now 0-3 NIU only having a 415-412 yd edge in a 31-25 win as a 14' pt HF. After winning 5 straight in the series from '14-'18 incl covering the last 2 at a 19+ fav, UT was embarrassed LY 52-14 as a 3 pt AD. We look for the Rockets to extract their revenge this year, especially as another loss would all but knock them out of the MAC West race.

OHIO by 24 over Bowling Green - Ohio has won 4 straight over BG covering L/3 by an avg 17 ppg despite being a DD fav in all 3. LY Ohio was off an OT loss to WM that knocked them out of the MAC East race. They took their frustrations out on BG winning 66-24 as a 20 pt AF putting up a ssn high 609 yds incl a ssn high 342 rush (8.6 ypc). Ohio is just 1-1 SU & ATS TY & only won 24-10 as a 27' pt HF over Akron 2 wks ago. Ohio was forced to cancel LW's game due to covid & injuries & could be short some players. BG is 0-3 SU & 1-2 ATS despite being a dog of 20'+ in all 3. Their only cover was LW as a 30' pt HD & the trailed that gm 35-3 into the 4Q before Buffalo took the foot off the gas for only win 42-17. With Ohio's roster a ?, the line may be just a bit too much.

Miami, Oh by 16 over AKRON - After 4 straight wins in series, Akron has lost the L/3 (1-2 ATS) but LY only lost 20-17 as a 31 pt AD despite Miami having a school record 12 sks. LW RedHawks found out less than 48 hrs prior that their gm vs rival Ohio was cancelled. They had been without several players incl QB Gabbert the week before in their 42-10 (+9) loss Buffalo but expect to get some back incl Gabbert. LW the Zips hung tough in the 1H vs rival Kent St only trailing 35-28 at HT as a 26' pt AD but were outscored 34-7 in 2H. Akron is 0-3 SU & 1-2 ATS but only lost 24-10 at Ohio as a 27' pt AD. LY Miami had already had the MAC East Title locked up may have looked past an 0-10 Akron. With just a 5 gm ssn & already with 1 loss, MIU will be focused on Akron TY.

Pittsburgh +26' over CLEMSON

Pittsburgh (+) over CLEMSON - Hard to believe, but Pitt actually won LTH back in '16. The Panthers are coming off a convincing 47-14 (+3) win over VTech which gave us an easy 3★ LPS winner! QB Pickett threw for a career high 404 yds and Pitt finished w/a ssn high 556. Clemson had their gm vs FSU cancelled just hours before kickoff due to a positive Covid test. The Tigers haven't ply'd since their loss at ND. Pitt is +68 ypg on the ssn and they are holding foes 71 ypg below their avg. Clem is +198 ypg and is holding foes 78 ypg below their avg. Pitt only scored 22 pts in 2 gms w/o QB Pickett but since his return they've put up 41 & 47. The Tigers are on a long layoff after allowing 47 pts & 519 yds vs ND. As we've mentioned many times, HC Narduzzi does his best work as a dog (16-7 ATS) and his Pitt team is the last to win in Death Valley. **FORECAST: CLEMSON by 14**

Tulsa by 4 over HOUSTON - Since '14 Hou is 5-1 SU, but TU is 4-2 ATS. TU is off another close win (30-24 in 2 OT vs Tulane, pick-6 to win gm) while Hou had their game vs SMU PPD. Hou's OFF has put up 420+ yds in all but 1 gm (Cin: 282) but face a DEF that has all'd 354 ypg the L/4 gms. TU's OFF against AAC foes is putting up 461 ypg but were down to their 3rd string QB Brin last wk as Smith & Boomer left with inj's (status this wk?) but Brin had 266 yds & 2 td's incl a Halil Mary to send the gm to OT. Hou's DEF has all'd 427 ypg vs AAC foes & all'd a comb'd 1,191 yds & 82 pts to UCF & Cincy. Hou is 2-0 ATS this ssn as a HF but TU is 10-5 ATS as an AAC AD the L6Y & we'll call for TU to pull the small upset here as they seem to pull these close wins wk after wk.

BOISE ST by 7 over San Jose St - Boise is 14-0 SU vs SJSt, but SJSt have covered the L/2 gms. Boise is off a 40-32 win at UH (4★ LP winner on OVER 55.5!) while SJSt had their gm canceled. The SJSt OFF is led by QB Starkel (980, 70%, 9-2) & their leading rusher is actually bkp QB Nash (177, 6.8). They face a Boise DEF that has all'd 349 ypg vs MW foes & they are holding MW foes to 112 pass ypg (faced USU & AF) but gave up 359 pass yds to BYU. Boise got QB Bachmeier back but were still w/o RB Holani last wk and their OFF is avg'g 402 yds vs MW foes. SJSt's DEF might be the biggest surprise as they are all'g 349 ypg 15 ppg TY. Boise is 6-1 ATS the L2Y as a MW HF, but SJSt is 7-2 ATS the L3Y as a DD MW dog & we think that SJSt can keep this gm close.

APPALACHIAN ST by 20 over Troy - As SBC foes App St is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS vs Troy & have won/covered the L/2 gms incl a 48-13 win last ssn. App St is off a tough loss to CCar while Troy was upset vs Mid Tenn. App Stavg 245 rush ypg (5.3) vs SBC foes as RB Peoples (544, 5.6) filled in nicely for inj'd Harrington. Troy's run D has been solid this ssn (163, 4.0) but did allow 210 yds vs GSt & 326 yds to GSthrn. Troy's passing attack (341 ypg vs SBC foes) takes on a tough App pass D that is all'g 187 ypg (47% comp all'd) this ssn. App St is just 1-3 ATS this ssn as a HF but Troy is 0-4 ATS under HC Lindsey as a DD underdog & we'll back an angry App St team to rebound with a convincing win.

UCLA by 10 over Arizona - The Bruins are on a 6-2 SU (5-3 ATS) run in this series although LY's trip to the desert saw the Wildcats (+6) capture a 20-17 upset victory despite missing their top QB and RB. While they were without QB DTR LW due to Covid tracing, the Bruins nearly pulled the upset of the Ducks in Eugene (3 pt loss, 462-422 yd edge, -3 TO's). UA meanwhile saw the Huskies jump out to a 37-0 lead after 3Q's before getting 27 pts in the final frame to make things a little closer than they actually were. Despite dropping ATS covers in 6 of their L/7 as home chalk, we like the Bruins in this one as the Wildcats continue to struggle as an AD with just a 5-16 ATS mark.

USC by 6 over Colorado - The Trojans are 14-0 SU all-time in the series but did see LY's trip to Boulder go right down to the wire with USC needing a pair of 4Q TD's to overcome a 10 point deficit (35-31 victory, -12). USC outscored Utah 9-0 in LW's 2H for a 33-17 victory (+3 TO's). The Buffs meanwhile come into this matchup sitting at a perfect 2-0 SU/ATS and on extra rest following LW's cancellation against ASU due to Covid. With CU off to a surprising start (both wins came as dogs) and USC seeing their 1st two games going down to the wire, we'll go ahead and call for the Buffs to stay within a td.

UTSA by 6 over North Texas - NT is 3-0 SU but the home team is 5-1 SU and 6-0 ATS. NT had 3 straight gms cancelled then ply'd Rice LW and won 27-17 (-2). QB Bean played the whole gm for the first time this ssn, only throwing for 120 yds but had 94 rush yds. UTSA led SMiss 23-10 (-9) LW but only won a fg. RB McCormick missed the previous gm (birth of child) and returned to rush for 173 and 2 td's but QB Harris only finished with 71 pass yds a week after throwing for 312 vs UTEP. NT is +39 ypg while UTSA is only +14 ypg but the RoadRunners have faced a tougher sked. RB McCormick leads CUSA with 1,094 (5.4) and should have a big game against NT's rush D that allows 211 (5.0).

OKLAHOMA ST by 13 over Texas Tech - From '09-17 OSU won 9 consec mtgs SU, but TT has covered 5 of the L/6 mtgs incl pulling the outright upset the L2Y. TT is off a bye while OSU lost 41-13 to rival OU. OSU's OFF has struggled the L/2 gms (251 ypg/17 ppg) & last wk both QB's Sanders & Ilingworth saw time (Sanders banged up, came back 4Q). The OSU run gm can get on track here (119 ypg, 3.0 ypc L/3 gms) vs a TT run D all'g 230 ypg (5.1) the L/3 gms. Before last wk OSU (492 yds all'd) had all'd 318 ypg to B12 foes & face a TT OFF avg'g just 360 yds the L/4 gms & have gone back & forth between QB's Bowman & Colombi. While TT has the series edge, they are just 1-5 ATS as a B12 AD the L2Y & we think OSU bonuces back off a loss to their rival.

Ohio St by 28 over ILLINOIS - OSU is 9-0 SU but IL is actually 5-3 ATS when hosting the Buckeyes. The Illini got QB Peters back (Covid) and put up a ssn high 490 yds, upsetting Neb 41-23 as 16' pt dogs (1 of 3 outright Big Dog winners, just \$9, call 1-800-654-3448). OSU held off a feisty Indiana team 42-35 (-20). The Buckeyes did finish with a +117 yd edge but QB Fields threw 3 ints and the 490 yds allowed was their most since 2018. IL is -66 ypg but they were ply'g their 4th string QB in 2 games. OSU has put up the most yds 3 of their foes have all'd but their DEF is giving up 7 ypg more than their foes avg. IL is 4-1 as an AD and 7-2 as double-digit dogs and OSU isn't as dominant as in year's past so our line stops at 28 for the Buckeyes.

Coastal Carolina by 21 over TEXAS ST - 3rd mtg as SBC foes, TXSt has covered both gms as a dog. CCar is off a big win vs App St while TXSt is off a 47-45 win vs Ark St (3★ LP Winner on the OVER 69). CCar's run-first OFF (202, 4.8 vs SBC foes) faces a TXSt rush D that is giving up 269 ypg (5.6) the L/5 wks, but they also give up 303 pass ypg (68% comp all'd) to non-option tms. The TXSt DEF is also all'g 86 ypg more than their foes avg and faces rFr CCar QB McCall (1593, 68%, 18-1). TXSt put up 505 yds LW but vs SBC foes avg 372 ypg and face a CCar DEF holding SBC foes to 120 ypg under their ssn avg. While TXSt is 4-1-1 ATS this ssn as a DD dog, CCar is 3-1 this ssn as SBC chalk & have to keep winning impressively to rise in the rankings.

ARKANSAS ST by 10 over South Alabama - Ark St is 6-2 SU/5-3 ATS vs SALa as SBC foes & the home team has won 4 str ATS with SALa pulling the outright upset at home LY. Ark St is off a loss at TXSt while SALa is off a loss at GSt & this is currently their ssn finale. Ark St is gaining 62 ypg more than what their foes allow. SALa has all'd 239 pass ypg (66% comp all'd) vs SBC foes. SALa is -98 ypg this ssn vs SBC foes & are only avg'g 298 ypg & 12 ppg over the L/4, but do face a Ark St DEF that is all'g 52 ypg above their foes ssn avg & have all'd 507 ypg the L/5 gms. While SALa is 9-5 ATS vs SBC foes the L2Y Ark St is an impressive 16-5 ATS as an SBC HF under HC Anderson.

ALABAMA by 31 over Auburn - Auburn won the Iron Bowl LY 48-45 (+3). The last 4 times HC Saban has been out for revenge against Auburn they've gone 4-0 SU/ATS, winning by 26.5 ppg! Bama has covered 4 straight after LW's 63-3 (-32) win over Kentucky. The Tide are +189 ypg and +218 ypg at home. Aub enters off a 30-17 win over Tenn but they were outgd by 79 yds and allowed 222 (5.4)

rush yds and lost RB Bigsby early in the gm. The Tide are avg 182 ypg more than their foes allow and QB Jones has an 18-3 ratio. QB Nix is 4-5 SU/5-4 ATS on the road and only completes 54% w/ an 11-10 ratio on the road. The Tide are 4-0 as HF TY while Aub is 4-9 as AD. Against common foes (Ole Miss, UGA, Tenn, Ark & KY) Bama is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS, +210 ypg & +31 ppg while Aub is 3-1 SU/ATS by +4 ppg & -87 ypg! Saban gets his revenge by almost 5 td's!

FAU by 8 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - The home tm is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series. FAU enters off 4 straight wins but failed to cover last Fri in their 24-2 (33') win over UMass. MT got revenge in their 2nd matchup with Troy TY, winning 20-17 (+12) after losing the first mtg by 33. The Blue Raiders have won 3 of their L/5 but are -131 ypg in those. FAU is +113 ypg in their L/4 and their top 2 offensive outputs have come after switching to duel threat QB Posey. MT allows 222 (5.2) rush ypg while FAU is avg 198 (4.5) rush ypg. FAU is holding foes 39 ypg below their avg while MT allows 66 ypg more than their foes avg. MT is 5-1 as a HD but FAU is 5-0 as an AF and on a 20-10-1 ATS run vs CUSA foes.

BAYLOR by 6 over Kansas ST - BU is 7-3 SU vs KSt, but the dog in this series is on a 9-1 ATS run. LW KSt was shutout vs ISU 45-0 (149-539) while BU is off a bye. KSt was down several plays last wk (covid) and KSt QB Howard was pulled last wk & there may be a QB battle now (OFF avg'g 248 yds/9 pts the L/3 gms). Despite BU losing 5 straight B12 gms they have all been by 11 pts or less & are just -50 ypg while KSt is -103 ypg. BU does have a vet QB in Brewer who gives them a big QB edge in this gm but the OFF is only putting up 321 ypg, but the DEF is all'g a steady 372 ypg. With both squads struggling heading into this matchup, we find it difficult to lean with either team.

TEXAS A&M by 21 over Lsu - LSU is 8-1 SU/9-0 ATS in this series but A&M has only been favored once and won that mtg in '18. A&M has had B2B gms ppd. Last week the Tigers gave us a 3★ winner on these pages in their 27-24 (-1') win at Ark. The Tigers have alternated losses with wins each gm this ssn while A&M enters on a 4 gm winning streak including an 11 pt win over Ark where they actually led by 25 in the 4Q. A&M is +106 ypg while LSU is -21 ypg and the Tigers are allowing foes to put up 123 ypg more than their avg. The Aggies are holding foes 92 ypg below their avg. QB Mond has a 14-2 ratio and LSU has fallen to #107 in our pass eff D ratings, giving up 14 td passes TY. A&M is 9-5 as a HF but 0-2 TY and LSU is 5-0 as an AD.

Tennessee by 7 over VANDERBILT - Believe it or not, Vandy has won 5 of the last 8 mtgs, are 7-1 ATS and those 5 wins have come by 16.2 ppg. Tenn enters off 5 straight losses. LW the Vols controlled TOP, outgained Aub by 79 yds, was even in TO's yet lost 30-17 (+10') at Aub. RB Gray rushed for 173 (7.9) and led with 49 rec yds. QB Guarantano threw his 4th pick 6 of the ssn and was benched for the 3rd time in 4 gms. Vandy led UF 10-7 2Q but lost 38-17 (+31'). QB Seals topped 300 yds for the 3rd time in 4 gms. Vandy is only 3-11 as a HD and the Vols do have a significant talent edge have major issues at AB and the 'Dores have confidence in this series.

RICE by 13 over Utep - Rice is 14-3 ATS in this series and have won 11 of the L/14. The Owls led NT 10-0 1Q LW then fumbled & was SOD in NT territory in their next 2 poss. Rice didn't score again until 4Q and lost 27-17 (+2). UTEP has had 4 of their L/6 gms ppd including LW vs UAB. The Miners have lost 3 straight and are -39 ypg on the ssn. Rice is +35 ypg and QB Collins has a 10-1 ratio. UTEP avg 122 ypg less than their foes allow while Rice avg 65 ypg less than their foes avg. UTEP is 2-5 as a single digit dog while Rice is 0-5 as a HF but we think the Owls will get the home win by nearly 2 td's.

OLE MISS by 14 over Mississippi St - UM is out for revenge after losing LY's Egg Bowl thanks to a shameful unsportsmanlike pen that led to a missed PAT. HC's Kiffin and Leach meet for the first time since '13 when Leach's Cougars were 15' pt dogs but upset Kiffin's Trojans. UM had their gm vs A&M ppd last week. MSU had their best effort since their opener LW, only losing 31-24 (+25) at Georgia. Ole Miss is allowing foes to put up 143 ypg more than their avg and twice allowed over 400 pass yds. MSU is holding foes 52 ypg below their avg. Ole Miss has a huge OFF edge but MSU has a defensive edge. We will call for the revenge minded Rebels to win by 2 td's.

Louisiana by 26 over ULM - While the road team is 18-2-1 dating back to '99, the dog is 17-3-1 ATS over the same time span. Both tms are coming off canceled games, but LA has locked up the SBC West while ULM is still winless. LA is avg'g 520 yds (244 rush ypg, 5.9 ypc) the L/3 gms & are facing a ULM D that is all'g 259 ypg (5.4) and are giving up 50 ypg above what their foes avg. While LA is clearly the better tm, they may be w/o HC Napier (tested positive for covid last wk) and this is the biggest line in series history. We don't feel strong leaning with either tm given that the two earlier angles cancel each other out.

Memphis by 20 over NAVY - As AAC foes Mem is just 1-4 ATS (2-3 SU) vs Navy with their lone ATS win coming LY (-10') when they won 35-23 despite being outgained 373-301 (Mem KR TD). Mem is off a 56-14 win vs FCS SF Austin while Navy's gm vs USF was PPD. Mem has all'd 338 rush ypg (4.9) in the L/5 gms vs Navy, but Navy is avg'g 187 rush ypg (3.8) this year & starting QB Morris has just 56 rush yds on 65 att (0.9 ypc!). Navy's DEF is all'g 445 ypg/37 ppg & face a Mem OFF led by QB White (2397, 62%, 23-6) that is avg'g 354 pass ypg. Against 3 strong pass teams (BYU, Hou, SMU) Navy has all'd 304 pass ypg. Mem is 11-5 ATS the L4Y as DD chalk vs AAC foes while Navy is 1-5 ATS the L3Y as a DD conf dog & have not played since Oct 31.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 3 over Louisville - BC has covered 3 straight series mtgs but UL won 41-39 (-5) LY. UL enters off a 30-0 (-19) win over Cuse where they held a 413-137 yd edge. BC had a scheduled bye LW and has alternated wins with losses the last 8 gms. QB Jurkovec got much needed rest after dealing with a seperated shoulder. The Eagles are -28 ypg while UL is +72. The Cardinals avg 36 ypg more than their foes allow. BC avg 41 ypg less than their foes allow. BC is 1-4 as a HF and we will call for Louisville to keep this closer than expected.

SUNDAY NOVEMBER 29TH
Utah at ARIZONA ST - The Utes finally became the last FBS squad to play a contest LW in SLC against the Trojans who took advantage of 5 Ute TO's in the 33-17 win. The Sun Devils meanwhile saw their 2nd consec contest canceled due to Covid issues in Tempe. ASU does own this series dating back to 1977 with a 13-3 SU mark. Utah did however pick up a 21-3 (-13') home win LY by holding the Sun Devils to just 8 FD's and 136 yds. While both roster's have had a rough first month due to the virus, keep in mind that ASU is just 2-6 ATS in recent home matchups.

KEY SELECTIONS

4★ NEW ENGLAND over Arizona - This marks the only HG in a 5-wk span for the Patriots who return to Foxboro following a narrow 7 pt loss to the Texans. The Cardinals meanwhile head to NE on extra rest after a Thur night trip to SEA where they fell by a TD (final drive ended at SEA 33). The Patriots have come out victorious in 6 of the past 7 matchups in this series including a 23-21 (+7) victory back in the '16 opener when they were without QB Brady due to suspension. While ARZ is clearly an up-and-coming squad that has covered 6 of their L/8 NDIV AG's, the Patriots are 11-5 ATS in NDIV HG's and haven't failed to cover as a regular ssn home dog since 2005 when Kyler Murray was just 8 yrs old!

The Rams meanwhile are sitting a half game out of 1st in the NFC West as of presstime with a MNF matchup against TB yet to be determined. In their 1st meeting of the 2020 campaign (Wk 6), a banged-up 49ers squad picked up a surprising 24-16 (+3) home victory (led 21-6 at HT). With the Rams going 9-4-1 ATS in overall DIV matchups as well as picking up cover in 7 of their L/10 as home chalk, we'll call for them to even up the series here as the 49ers have gone a porous 1-7 ATS following their bye week.

2★ NY JETS (+) over Miami - While the Jets have yet to taste victory this ssn following their 10th consec loss LW on the road against the Chargers (outgained 376-292 in a 6 pt defeat), they have actually covered the past 2 heading into their matchup against the Dolphins. MIA meanwhile saw their 5-gm SU/ATS winning streak snapped LW in DEN as they were held to just 222 yds (Fitzpatrick came in for the struggling Tagovailoa in the 4Q). In their earlier Wk 6 meeting in South Beach, the Dolphins (-8) picked up their 1st shutout since '14 holding the Jets to just 13 FD's and 263 yds. While MIA has actually covered 6 of their L/9 DIV matchups coming in, leaning in their direction could be risky as the Jets are a solid 13-4 ATS as a DIV HD coming in.

Thursday Nov 26th

Houston by 6 over DETROIT - After putting together a perfect 4-0 SU/ATS run on Thanksgiving from '13-'16 with a 20 pt avg MOV, the Lions have turned into turkey's the L/3 ssn's with an 0-3 SU/ATS mark (-6 ppg). Their trip to Charlotte LW didn't fair too well as the Panthers held them to just 10 FD's and 185 yds in a 20-0 victory. HOU meanwhile picked up just their 3rd win of the '20 campaign LW at home vs NE with a 380 tti yd, 3 TD effort by QB Watson. The Texans have picked up 3 consec victories in this series (1-1-1 ATS, 6 pt avg MOV) including a 20-13 home win back in '16. While they have gone just 3-7-1 ATS in matchups with the NFC, the Lions have now failed to cover 15 of their L/19 overall coming in.

DALLAS by 7 over Washington - This marks the 1st of 3 consec AG's for WAS who heads into DAL following a 20-9 win over the Bengals. The Cowboys meanwhile get their only HG in a 4-wk span following a surprising 3 pt upset victory in MIN (QB Dalton 3 TD's) and a Thur trip to BAL on deck. In their earlier meeting back in Wk 7, WAS knocked off the Cowboys for just the 2nd time in the L/5 years with a dominant 25-3 victory (397-142 yd edge). While WAS has won just 1 of their 8 Thanksgiving matches against DAL coming in, the Cowboys have also struggled on this holiday lately with just a 1-5 ATS mark. DAL is however 15-6 ATS in overall DIV matchups and should get some revenge from earlier this season in this one.

Baltimore at PITTSBURGH - TNF - Following a relatively easy win LW in JAX (23-14 FD & 373-206 yd edges in 24 pt victory) to remain undefeated on the ssn, the Steelers return to Heinz Field looking for the sweep against a Ravens squad who suffered a surprising OT defeat LW at home vs the Titans (TEN 422-306 yd edge). Despite a substantial 457-221 yd deficit a few wks back in BAL, the Steelers picked up a 28-24 victory thanks mainly to a 4-1 TO edge and a late goaline stop. While PIT is on an outstanding 7-1 ATS run coming in, laying points against a BAL team who is 9-1-2 ATS as an AD could be risky.

Las Vegas by 6 over ATLANTA - After a 15 pt loss to the Saints inside of the Superdome where they were held to just 9 pts, 14 FD's and 248 yds (sk'd 8 times, 2 TO's), the Falcons hop into non-conf play before a home matchup against that very same Saints squad. The Raiders meanwhile saw their 3-game winning streak snapped LW at home against the Chiefs who got a GW 22-yd TD pass w/:28 left. While the Falcons have won 4 straight matchups in this series dating back to '04 (3-1 ATS) with a 15 pt avg MOV, they have failed to cover 13 of their L/15 meetings against the AFC. The Raiders on the other hand are 6-1 ATS away from home and need a win here to remain in solid playoff contention.

Ny Giants by 6 over CINCINNATI - This marks the only home matchup in a 4-wk span for the Bengals who return to CIN following a pair of road losses in PIT and WAS (20-9 defeat, lost rookie QB Burrow for ssn w/knee inj). While the Giants are sitting at just 3-7 on the ssn, they do return from their bye week sitting just a half game back in the rugged NFC East. In their most recent meeting back in '16, the Giants (+1) finished with 23-12 FD and 351-264 yd edges in a 21-20 victory on MNF. While the Bengals are on a 7-3-1 ATS run coming in, we expect the Giants to get it done here as they've covered 8 straight road contests.

Cleveland by 4 over JACKSONVILLE - After picking up a 5 pt win LW at home against the Eagles (4★ Newsletter Winner) where their defense forced 5 sks & 3 TO's (incl a 50 yd IR TD), the Browns head South to take on a JAX squad that was held to just 14 FD's & 206 yds in a 27-3 loss to the Steelers. The Jags have actually won and covered the past 3 meetings with the Browns including a 19-7 home victory back in '17. While JAX has failed to cover 21 of their L/29 as a NDIV HD, we'll call for the home team to stay within the line here as CLE is just 1-7 ATS as an AF.

MINNESOTA by 7 over Carolina - The Vikings saw their 3-gm winning streak snapped LW at home vs DAL who got a GW 2-yd TD pass w/1:37 left (MIN 434-376 yd edge). The Panthers meanwhile ended a 5-game losing skid LW in Charlotte against the Lions with their defense allowing just 10 FD's & 185 yds in their 20-0 shutout without inj'd QB Bridgewater (bkp QB Walker 24-34-258-1-2 in 1st career start). In their most recent matchup back in '17, the Panthers (+2) picked up a 31-24 home victory by getting a GW 1-yd TD run w/1:47 remaining. While the Panthers have covered 4 straight as an AD TY including a pair of outright upsets against the Falcons and Chargers, we expect the Vikings to bounce back here as they've gone 23-11-3 ATS as a HF.

INDIANAPOLIS by 7 over Tennessee - The Titans and Colts met just 17 days ago in Nashville with IND getting 21 unanswered points in the 2H for the 34-17 victory (430-294 yd edge). The Titans picked up a surprising 30-24 OT victory LW in BAL with RB Henry getting the GW 29-yd TD run (TEN 422-306 yd edge). The Colts meanwhile picked up an OT win over the Packers (420-367 yd edge) in a game that they trailed by 14 at HT (GB 4 TO's incl 1 in OT). With the Colts dominating the overall series dating back to '12 with a 14-3 SU (11-5-1 ATS) mark and covering 7 of their L/10 inside the DIV, we have no issue backing them in this one.

BUFFALO by 8 over La Chargers - Behind another big day from rookie QB Herbert (366 yds, 3 TD's), the Chargers had no problem knocking off the winless Jets at home (LAC 376-292 yd edge). The Bills meanwhile return from their bye week with a chip on their shoulder following a last second loss in the desert to the Cardinals (ARZ GW Hail Mary TD w/:02 left!). The Chargers have picked up 4 consec wins and covers in this series dating back to '11 (20 pt avg MOV) including a 31-20 (-7) victory in BUF 2 yrs ago. They are however on just a 4-11-2 overall ATS run. With the Bills needing a win here to stay on top of the AFC East standings, we have no issue leaning in their direction for this one.

New Orleans by 3 over DENVER - Following a 15 pt win over the Falcons with QB Hill (284 tti yds, 2 TD's) starting for the inj'd Brees, the Saints begin a 3-game road trip against a DEN squad that held the red-hot Dolphins to just 13 pts and 222 yds in the upset victory. The Broncos have picked up 5 straight victories in this series (4-1 ATS) including a miracle win in the last meeting inside of the Superdome. With the Saints getting a 32-yd TD pass w/1:22 left to tie up the game, the Broncos blocked what would have been the go-ahead PAT by the Saints and returned it for a 2 pt conv and a 25-23 win. While the red-hot Saints have covered 15 of their L/20 away matchups, the Broncos are on a 7-1-1 ATS run as a NDIV HD and are expected to stay within the line.

Kansas City by 6 over TAMPA BAY - The Bucs have owned this series dating back to '09 with a perfect 5-0 SU/ATS mark and a 9 pt avg MOV. They are back at home on short rest however after a MNF matchup against the Rams. The Chiefs meanwhile picked up a 4 pt win LW in Vegas (460-364 yd edge) following their bye week as QB Mahomes threw the GW 22-yd TD pass w/:28 left. With KC posting a 23-9 ATS mark as away chalk coming in and the Bucs failing to cover 9 of their L/11 prior to their bye week, we're counting on the visitor to get the job done in this one.

Chicago at GREEN BAY - SNF - After a non-conf road trip to IND where they were tripped up in OT thanks in part to 4 TO's, the Packers return to Lambeau to take on a struggling Bears squad that dropped 4 straight (1-3 ATS) prior to their bye week including a 6 pt loss on MNF at home against the Vikings where they were held to just 10 FD's and 149 yds. With their 2-game sweep of the Bears a ssn ago, the Packers have now won 7 of the L/8 (5-3 ATS) dating back to '16. While CHI is an impressive 11-4 ATS vs DIV foes, it's unclear who will be lining up under center at QB as of presstime. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Seattle at PHILADELPHIA - MNF - Following a rough 3 week run against some of the NFL's top teams that includes a 7 pt win over the Cardinals last Thur, the Seahawks' schedule gets much easier with their next 4 foes combining for just a 9-30-1 run entering Wk 12. The Eagles meanwhile are at home for the only time in a 4-wk span following a pair of defeats at NYG and CLE (3★ LP Winner on Under 46!). These 2 met on 2 occasions a year ago with SEA picking up identical 17-9 victories (incl a win at PHI in the WC Rnd). In fact, the Seahawks have actually picked up 6 consec wins over PHI dating back to '11 (11 pt avg MOV). Will that be enough to lean with them here against a PHI squad that's covered 6 of their L/9 as a HD?
