4★ †Notre Dame over Army - This game is being played at Yankee Stadium where these two met 24 times between 1924-1946. Army has lost their last 15 vs ND but the last mtg was back in '16. This is ND's 2nd time facing the option and a few weeks ago we cashed a 3H on these pages and a 4H LPS when the Irish smoked Navy 51-14 (-14). ND has won 9 straight by 29 ppg. LW they were upset 35-0 on Virginia but allowed 2 td's and a backdoor cover with :18 left. Army is 9-0 but their toughest test came at North Texas 2 weeks ago. Both tms combined for just 12 possessions and NT was SOD at the Army 2 and intercepted at the Army 11 & 2. ND is +139 ypg against our #50 sked while Army is 146 but has played the weakest schedule in the FBS (#134). We were surprised to see ND is only laying 2 td's here considering how badly they beat Navy so we are making this our 4★ top Power Sweep play!

FORECAST: Notre Dame by 24

3★ Indiana (+) over OHIO ST - Both teams enter this game off a bye and the winner will be in a good place to reach the B10 title game. Ohio St enters this game holding foes to 126 ypg under their season avg (#2 FBS!) and over the L4 games are allowing just 250 ypg/9 ppg, however their L2 games were against Purdue and N'Western. Indiana's offense is putting up 415 ypg/40ppg and QB Rourke is hitting 72% with a 21-4 ratio and have a 4 RB rotation with 4 exp'd RB's led by RB Ellison (686, 5.7) and Lawton (508, 4.8). Indiana is allowing just 285 ypg/16 ppg and are holding foes to 79 ypg under their avg (#17). OSU has the schedule edge (#52 vs #79) but this Indiana team is confident & OSU hasn't really impressed us in any game. We'll lean with the Hoosiers, who are a DD underdog and HC Cignetti will have them believing they can win this game outright.

FORECAST: OHIO ST by 3

3★ Colorado St over FRESNO ST - Colo St enters here having won 5 straight and have covered 7 straight. Over the L4 games CSU is avg'g 204 rush ypg (5.3) led by RB's Morrow and Marshall and in their last game Fresno allowed 344 rush (4.3) to Air Force. On the season Fresno is -75 ypg in MW play and CSU is +8 ypg. CSU's OL is not only paving the way for good rushing totals, they have not allowed a sack in the L4 games. Fresno's offense is only putting up 294 ypg the L4 games and QB Keene has just an 15-11 ratio. CSU QB Fowler-Nicolosi started the season with a 2-4 ratio in the F4 games but since has a 6-1 ratio. The Rams are unbeaten in MW play and if they win out they'll be in the MW title game. We like the Rams to pull the outright upset in this one.

FORECAST: Colorado St by 6

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ MICHIGAN over Northwestern - Who would have thought Mich would still need a win to reach a bowl at this point in the ssn? With a game vs a hungry OSU team on deck this is their best shot at win #6. Mich has only put up 266 ypg/16 ppg the L4 gms, but all 3 of their B10 wins are at home. Mich's defense is still very talented, holding foes to 67 ypg under their avg (#21) overall allow just 335 ypg/23 ppg and hold teams to just 116 rush ypg (3.6) in B10 play. NW is avg'g just 254 ypg in B10 play and were held to just 159 yds LW vs Ohio St after their 92 yd td drive to open the gm. NW is also -114 ypg on the road. Mich has an edge in ST's (#22 vs 60) and have faced the #7 schedule (NW #44). Mich will be motivated at home and it may be tough for NW to score at all.

FORECAST: MICHIGAN by 18

2★ ARKANSAS ST over ULM - Ark St has dominated this series, winning and covering 14 straight games! Ark St has pulled the outright upset in 2 of the last 3 meetings and 10 of the L12 meetings have been DD wins by Ark St. After starting 5-1, ULM has dropped 4 straight and are -130 ypg/-22 ppg in their L4 games. Their defense is allowing 448 ypg and 271 rush ypg (5.8) over the L4 games. Ark St has won 3 of the L4 games and are putting up 440 ypg incl 234 rush ypg (5.6) over the L4 games. Ark St has won all 4 home games and are +21 ypg at home while ULM is -162 ypg on the road. These teams are trending in opposite directions and ULM is not a good road team. With the line hovering around a fg we like the Red Wolves by DD's!

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 20th

TOLEDO by 3 over Ohio - Toledo has won & covered the L2 games. Last met in the '22 MAC title game and Ohio was playing with backup QB and the Rockets won 17-7 (+128 yds). Ohio has played good ball of late as they are on a 3 game SU/ATS win streak, winning by 32 ppg and are +189 ypg in those 3 games. Toledo needs a win here to stay in the MAC title race and do have the most talented team in the conf. Ohio is holding MAC foes to 260 ypg/15 ppg and overall are holding tms to 40 ypg under their avg while Toledo is holding tms to 10 ypg under their avg. Ohio QB Navarro does only have 7-8 ratio and their wins are over some of the lesser MAC tms. Toledo has the ST edge (#2 vs #134) and that could be the difference here.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 6 over Buffalo - EMich pulled a road upset over Buffalo LY 24-11 (+4'). Buffalo won the previous 3 meetings including in Ypsilanti in both '19 & '22 by 29 & 19 points. EMich still needs a win to reach a bowl after losing their last 3. Two of those losses were to MAC favorites Toledo & Ohio. Buff trailed Ball ST 45-31 4Q but rallied to win in OT and clinched a bowl in the process. Bulls QB CJ Ogbonna has a 13-4 ratio and RB Al-Jay Henderson has topped 100 yds in 2 straight. EMich QB Cole Snyder threw 3 int's last week but does have a 12-6 ratio. Buff is -65 ypg vs the MAC and -206 on the road while EMich is only -5 vs the MAC and +38 at home. EMich has the better offense and defense and are at home so we give them a 6 point edge.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 21st

NC State at GEORGIA TECH - These 2 haven't met since '20, GT's first year going away from the triple option. NCSt still needs a win to reach a bowl and they finish with 2 road games at GT and NC. The Wolfpack are fresh off a bye but two weeks ago lost 29-19 at home to Duke. GT is 6-4 and also fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they upset Miami 28-23. Haynes King should be back to 100%. The Jackets are +39 ypg vs ACC foes while NCSt is +16 and GT has ply'd a tougher sked (#34 vs #59). GT was 2-11-1 as a HF entering '24 but 3-0 this year. Call 1-800-654-3448 or goto www.NCSports.com and get our Thursday Marquee for \$15.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 22nd

UTSA by 17 over Temple - UTSA won the only prior meeting 49-34 (-14) last year. Temple beat FAU 18-15 (-2) but still fired HC Stan Drayton. Everett Withers takes over as Interim HC, a role he also held for a full season at North Carolina in 2011. He has a 32-41 career record. UTSA needs one more win to reach a bowl. They have won their last two games and their last loss came after leading Tulsa 35-7 H and 42-17 4Q. UTSA is +61 ypg and +101 vs the AAC. Temple is -102 ypg and -122 vs the AAC. The Owls are 0-5 SU/1-4 ATS on the road 52-6 and was outgained 589-158. Withers is a quality Interim HC and the teams who have fired their HC has done well so we are putting this at the line.

MICHIGAN ST by 17 over Purdue - Purdue has covered 5 of the L6 meetings (all 5 covers as an underdog). Purdue won the last meeting 40-29 back in 2021. Purdue is the worst team in the B10 and they are allowing foes to gain 109 ypg above their avg (#130 FBS) and their offense is getting held to 31 ypg under what their foes allow (#104 FBS) and in B10 play Purdue is -178 ypg/-27 ppg in B10 play. Mich St holds teams to 43 ypg under their season avg and the defense has allowed just

328 ypg the L4 games. Mich St has the big edge on defense (#43 vs #102) and ST (#77 vs #111) and Mich St needs 2 wins to reach a bowl, so will be highly motivated to win this game and Purdue is just 1-8 ATS vs FBS teams this season. We like Sparty here by over 2 td's.

Unlv by 13 over SAN JOSE ST - As MW foes San Jose St is 9-2 SU/ATS against UNLV and are riding a 4-game SU/ATS win streak in the series. SJSt is 6-4 on the season and have outperformed expectations. They are avg'g 331 pass ypg in MW play and WR Nash as 95 rec for 1281 yds but QB Eget has just a 6-8 ratio and the Rebels have the #31 pass D and have recorded 16 int's on the season. SJSt's defense allows foes to gain 32 ypg above their season avg (#103) and have played just the #113 schedule. SJSt the L2 games have allowed 474 and 456 yds and UNLV avg's 469 ypg/41 ppg in MW play and UNLV is rushing for 230 ypg (5.3 the L4 gms). UNLV also has a big ST edge (#1 vs #113) and have 6 blocked punts. We like the Rebels here by almost 2 td's.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 23rd

Georgia Southern by 3 over COASTAL CAROLINA - GSthrn is off a bad performance at home vs Troy where they were outgained by 195 yds and lost 28-20. Coastal was at Marshall and fell behind 17-7 HT and 31-10 4Q but made a bit of a comeback & lost by 12. GSthrn sits at 4-2 in SBC play and still have a shot at the SBC title game while CC is just 2-4 in conf. CC is -65 ypg in SBC play while GSthrn is -27 ypg and CC has the #109 pass D (60%, 21-6). Off a loss vs ODU a few weeks back and in their next game upset S.Alb. Coastal allows foes to gain 19 ypg above their avg (#97) and we like the Eagles to bounce back and get the win & are a slight dog here & we think GSthrn gets the outright win led by QB Frech (65%, 14-7 ratio).

Smu by 7 over VIRGINIA - First meeting. A win here will clinch a spot in the ACC title game for SMU while UVA needs a win to be bowl elig. SMU has won 7 straight by 17.2 ppg and are +100 ypg in ACC play but they've avoided 4 of the 5 ACC teams that have a winning ACC record. Last week they were -18 at home vs BC but trailed 21-20 3Q and led 31-28 then scored their final td with :08 left. UVA is 5-5, has lost 4 of their last 5 and are -56 ypg in ACC play. They were down 35-0 3Q at Notre Dame but scored the final 2 td's including one with just :18 left for a backdoor cover. QB Anthony Colandrea was benched after throwing 3 int's and Tony Muskettt ran for UVA's only 2 td's. He was the starting QB when UVA upset UNC and nearly upset Miami last year. 3 of SMU's 4 road wins this year are by 7 or less and UVA is 10-2 ATS with 8 straight covers as a dog of 7+ points so we are taking the Cavaliers to keep it closer than expected.

LOUISVILLE by 3 over Pittsburgh - Pitt is 7-2-1 ATS vs L'ville since '07. UL is out for revenge. LY the Cardinals were 6-0 coming in and -7. They led 21-14 at half and finished w/a 430-288 yd edge but lost by 17. This year they come in 6-4 and all four losses have come by 7 points or less. LW they led Stanford 35-21 4Q then allowed 75 & 76 yd td drives, they were SOD at the Stan45 and 2 penalties but Stanford in fg range and UL lost on the games final play. Pitt started this ssn 7-0 but they've now lost 3 straight. LW they led Clemson 20-17 4Q but allowed QB Klubnick to run for a 50 yd td and Pitt lost by 4. Eli Holstein missed the game but Nate Yarnell threw for 350 yards. Pitt LB Kyle Louis is an AA candidate. Pitt has 11 sacks in their last 2 games and 34 on the season but they also allowed 8 sacks LW vs Clemson. Six of UL's last 7 games have been decided by 7 pts or less yet they are laying over a td here and we think the line should be closer to a fg.

JACKSONVILLE ST by 7 over Sam Houston - LY SH led 21-7 at half w/a 271-143 yd edge but lost 35-28 in OT. Both teams have a shot at the CUSA Title game. SH has won 3 straight, all by 6 points or less. LW they were -19 at Kennesaw St who just fired their coach. SH had a 382-243 yd edge but need OT in a 23-17 win. Jax St's won 7 straight but the last 3 were extremely close. Lib was driving to go ahead in 4Q but was SOD and Jax St got a pick-6 to win by 10. They needed a Hail Mary to beat LT in OT then LW were trailing FIU in the 4Q. SH is +86 ypg in CUSA play. SH beat LT and FIU by nearly the same margins. SH is 10-3 as an away dog since '19 and are back in that role after being favored the last five games so we think they keep it within a 7 point margin.

MIAMI, FL by 17 over Wake Forest - WF has lost all 5 meetings with UM since '04 but did cover the last 2. They last met in '13 when UM was -25 and only won 24-21. Now UM is -24' and fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they were -9' at GTech and lost by 5. They also trailed Duke by 11 3Q, were tied with L'ville 4Q, trailed by 25 3Q at Cal and trailed 34-24 vs VTech 4Q yet won all 4 of those games. The Deacons have lost their last two but we did cash a 3★ LPS LW with WF only losing at NCar 31-24 (+10). WF is -62 ypg in ACC play while Miami is +132. Miami is 7-17 ATS as DD chalk while WF is 5-2 as an ACC AF of 21+ points so our lean is with the Deacons.

WEST VIRGINIA by 3 over Ucf - In their first meeting as Big 12 foes last season WVU was +7 and benefitted from +3 TO's and won the game outright 41-28. WVU is one win away from getting to a bowl & are on the road at Tex Tech next week, so this is their best shot at win #6. WVU did put up 499 yds last week as QB Greene returned & threw for 237 and ran for 129. UCF has struggled at times to stop the run, allowing 256 (5.2) to BYU and 252 (4.9) to Kan St and WVU avg's 199 (4.8) in B12 play and ran for 262 (5.3) last week. WVU does allow just 135 rush (3.9) in B12 play and face a running QB in practice so they know how to defend it. WVU is shockingly the home dog here & we like WVU to win outright as the weather will be cold and possibly rainy, which favors the home team.

Bowling Green by 7 over BALL ST - BG is 8-2 SU and has won the last 2 over Ball St but they've met just once since '15. BG enters 6-4 and are tied for the top spot in the MAC at 5-1. They've won 4 straight including a 15 point win at Toledo. Ball St has been snake bit with 4 close losses in MAC play which led to Mike Neu's firing last week. The Cardinals are 3-7 but only -25 ypg in MAC play and only lost by 6 to Miami, OH two weeks ago. BG is +78 ypg in MAC play but plays down to the level of their competition against weaker foes (7 pt win at Akron, didn't cover vs Kent or CMich). We expect BG to win but the teams who fired their HC this year are 4-0 ATS so we are cutting our line off at 7.

North Carolina by 7 over BOSTON COLLEGE - NC has won the last 5 meetings though they haven't met since '20. The Heels reached bowl elig LW by beating WF 31-24 (-10) and they've now won 3 straight. BC started 4-1 but they've lost 4 of their last 5. They were +18 LW at SMU but led 21-20 3Q and never trailed by more than 10. NC is +75 ypg and +43 vs the ACC. BC is -19 ypg and -54 vs the ACC. BC is 4-1 at home but have been outgained in all 4 FBS home games (-88 ypg home vs FBS). Heels are only laying a fg here and they have actually been better on the road this year, winning 3 of 4 and are +115 away while only +49 at home. Go with the battle tested road team, Heels by a td.

Virginia Tech by 10 over DUKE - Former Coastal Division rivals meet for first time since '22 when Duke won 24-7 (+9'). VT had won their previous 9 trips to Durham. The Hokies should be healthier after their bye. VT has lost 2 straight but QB Drones and RB Tuten both missed their 6 pt loss at Cuse and were less than 100% against Clemson. Duke is the surprise of the ACC at 7-3 and also fresh off a bye. QB Manny Diaz brought his TO Chain mentality with him and Duke is +11 TO's. We give VT the edge in all 3 phases including a big ST's edge (#21 vs #81). Duke has close wins over weak foes like NW, UConn and FSU. We think VT is the better team and their last 12 wins have come by double-digits so it only makes sense that our line is 10 points.

Colorado by 6 over KANSAS - The Buffs are rolling right now, having won 7 of their L8 games and are on an 8-game ATS win streak. Last week we won a 4★ on these pages with the Buffs, as they beat Utah 49-24 (+133 yds) as QB Sanders threw for 340 yds & 3 td & the Buffs D picked off Utah's QB 3 times. KU also continued their winning ways, upsetting BYU on the road 17-13 as KU's go-ahead TD (1 play, 3 yard drive) was set up by a muffed punt. The L4 games KU is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS after losing 5 straight games in which they had the lead in the 2H. KU does have the #61 pass D and CU QB Sanders has a 27-7 ratio and his top 3 WR's all have 500+ yards. CU's defense has stepped up, holding foes to 62 ypg under their avg & have 32 sacks, plus allow just 136 rush ypg (3.5) in B12 play. Both tms are playing well, but we'll ride the Buffs streak here.

Ole Miss by 6 over FLORIDA - These two last met in the '20 opener won by Florida 51-35 (-14). The Gators turned their season around last week by upsetting LSU 27-16 at home and now they host an Ole Miss squad that lost to LSU last month. QB DJ Lagway returned last week and threw for 226 yards and 1 td. The Gators D had 7 sacks on an LSU Oline that had allowed just 6 sacks all season. LB Shemar James had 11 tackles and 2 sacks. Ole Miss is fresh off a bye and has won 3 straight including their last game where they dominated Georgia 28-10 (+2') with a 397-245 yd edge. QB Dart has a 22-4 ratio. FL has played a much tougher sked (#6 vs #63) including a close loss at Tenn and was beating UGA until Lagway was injured. Ole Miss has a lot of firepower but Florida is a different team when healthy and Napier is 25-13-1 ATS as a dog so our lean is with the Gators.

Marshall by 1 over OLD DOMINION - Marshall enters this game having won 4 straight since their 24-23 meltdown loss to GStHm. ODU did play JMU close last week, but trailed 35-24 before scoring a late td to make it a 35-32 loss. MU won last week despite not having RB Turner (793, 6.2) and he is ? here. But QB Braxton is a great dual-threat talent (13-2 ratio passing, 389, 4.7 rush) and MU's defense is allowing just 347 ypg the L/4 games. MU also has 30 sacks, led by stud DE Green who has 15 sacks! ODU just allowed 233 rush (4.9) last week. ODU has played the tougher schedule (#55 vs #105), but Marshall needs a win to remain ahead in the SBC East race and they are the dog in this matchup & we like them to win outright.

SYRACUSE by 7 over UConn - Former Big East rivals meet again. Cuse won the last meeting in '22 48-14 (-23') on the road. UConn is 7-3 and this is only their 4th road game. The Huskies are fresh off a bye and 2 weeks ago they trailed UAB 20-3 at half but won 31-23. Cuse is also 7-3 and they are 4-1 SU/2-2-1 ATS at home including wins over VTech and GTech. This is UConn's 3rd game vs an ACC foe and they lost both in close games to Duke by 5 and WF by 3. Cuse pulled their 4th upset of the season LW, beating Cal 33-25 (+10) and they've lost 2 of the 3 games following their previous upsets. The Orange is laying 10' points which feels like a lot against a UConn team that keeps games close.

FAU by 3 over Charlotte - Both Charlotte and FAU made surprising decisions to fire their 2nd year HC's this week. Both teams will be led by Interims with HC experience. FAU's Chad Lunsford was Georgia Southern's Interim HC in '27 then promoted to HC from '18-'21 and had a 28-21 record. CLT's Interim is Tim Brewster who had a 15-30 record and led Minnesota to 2 bowls. CLT comes in 3-7 and has lost 4 straight. FAU is 2-8 and has lost 5 straight. CLT has ply'd a much tougher sked (#67 vs #111) but we are giving the home Owls a 3 point edge.

USF by 21 over Tulsa - These two last met in '22 when Tulsa won 48-42 (-14) but both were under previous HC's. USF needs 1 win to be bowl eligible and is heavily favored here. USF is off a misleading 59-24 (-2') win over Charlotte. The Bulls only led 14-10 at half. It was 31-17 when USF got an IR td and FR td to pull away. Tulsa has proven to be one of the weakest teams in the AAC. They are 3-7 and -155 ypg vs the AAC while USF is only -56. Tulsa has losses by 38, 42, 32 & 35 this year and USF has wins by 45, 35, 23 & 35 so laying 17 points at home doesn't seem too daunting.

James Madison by 3 over APPALACHIAN ST - Met for the first time as SBC foes last season with JMU having an unbeaten record & App St (+9') pulled the outright upset 26-23. JMU is +87 ypg/+11 ppg in SBC play and are led by QB Barnett (59%, 22-2 ratio). However JMU has played the much weaker schedule (#124) and App has faced #77 schedule. Despite the 4-5 record App St is +10 ypg in SBC play and are avg'g 417 ypg in SBC play. RB Pettaway (741, 5.9) Both of JMU's losses are on the road this season and App St needs a win to try and keep their bowl hopes alive. While we like JMU to win, App St will be going all out to win here & are a home dog. App St is 3-0 ATS as a home dog since '21 and we think this is a close game.

NEBRASKA by 6 over Wisconsin - Since 2014 Wisconsin has won 9 straight vs Nebraska (5-4 ATS). Wisky started the season 5-2 SU but have dropped 3 straight games. Last week they hosted #1 Oregon and led 10-6 HT and 13-6 into the 4Q but allowed UO to come back & win 16-13. Over their L/3 games Wisky has put up just 261 ypg and are -137 ypg. They face a Nebraska defense that holds foes to 67 ypg under their season avg (233 FBS) and they allow just 295 ypg at home and are +71 ypg/+13 ppg at home. Nebraska is in search of that elusive 6th win (L28 straight games when they have 5 wins) and have played Ohio, UCLA and USC all close and with Wisky off a max effort game, we like the Huskers to capture that 6th win at home.

Penn St by 17 over MINNESOTA - Penn St has won 6 of the L/8 meetings but have only met 5 times since 2013. Penn St is now 9-1 on the season and are holding teams to 103 ypg under their season avg (#6 FBS) and only allow 273 ypg/14 ppg. Minn's offense struggles to move the ball, as they are getting held to 42 ypg under what their foes allow (#112 FBS) and put up just 326 ypg in B10 play. PSU meanwhile puts up 418 ypg in B10 play and 483 ypg/36 ppg on the road led by RB's Allen and Singleton, plus QB Allar is hitting 72% with a 16-5 ratio. PSU HC Franklin is 8-1 ATS the L/3 seasons as an away favorite in B10 play & we like the Nittany Lions by over 2 td's.

Iowa by 11 over MARYLAND - Last met in 2021 with Iowa winning 51-14 at Maryland as they were +157 yds and were +7 TO's!! Iowa is off a bye and 2 weeks ago lost at UCLA 20-17. They lost QB Sullivan so it will either be Jackson Stratton or a returning McNamara. Iowa's offense revolves around RB Johnson, who has 1,328 rush yds (7.1, 20 td). Maryland has dropped 5 of their L/6 games including 3 in a row. The defense is allowing 411 ypg/36 ppg in B10 play and all 5 B10 losses by Maryland are by 14 or more points. Iowa HC Ferentz is 20-8-1 ATS as an away favorite since 2014 and off the bye we feel like Iowa will bounce back and be able to handle a Maryland team that is trending in the wrong direction.

RUTGERS by 3 over Illinois - Last met in 2021 with Rutgers winning 20-14. ILL delivered a 3H winner on these oages for us last week with a 38-16 win vs Mich St where QB Altmeyer threw for 231 and 2 td. On the ssn Altmeyer is hitting 62% with a 18-3 ratio and Rutgers has allowed 322 pass ypg (66%) the L/4 games. ILL also had 5 sks LW but Rutgers has all'd just 15 sks all ssn. ILL is -155 ypg on the road but played Neb, Ore and Penn St. Rutgers has gotten 2 straight wins and in their last home game allowed just 297 yds to Minn & here it is their home finale. ILL has a good team and this will be a close game, but we'll call for the home team by a fg.

GEORGIA by 35 over UMass - Massive sandwich for Georgia, coming off their 14 point win over Tennessee and they have rival GTech on deck. Dawgs are -42' and are 0-12-1 ATS when laying over 40 points. This is UMass' 3rd game vs an SEC foe this year. They had been 9-1 ATS entering '24 but didn't cover against either Mizzou or Miss St. However both of those teams were coming off a loss and Miss St was in desperation mode after losing 7 straight. Walk-Ons will play most of the 2H for Georgia and Kirby doesn't embarrass inferior opponents so we lean with the dog.

LIBERTY by 7 over Wku - Loser of this game is eliminated from the CUSA Title game. Flames are a hard team to figure out. They were 5-0 but underwhelming as large favorites in each game then were upset by Kennesaw St at 28 pt chalk. They had Jax St on the ropes but lost then rebounded to beat Middle Tenn by 20. Last week in a letdown spot they trailed UMass 20-7 at half but won 35-34 (+15') in OT. WKU was held to 215 yards and 7 pts LW in a 5 point loss to LA Tech. WKU is +61 ypg vs CUSA while Lib is +86. The Flames are 1-16 ATS when favored by 14 pts or more but are 11-2 ATS when favored by less than 14 pts under Chadwell. Lib is only -1' and we think they are the better team at at home.

TENNESSEE by 49 over Utep - Vols are 3-0 in this series and won last 2 mtgs (1990 & 2018) by combined 80-0. Under Heupel Tenn has crushed weak non-conf foes including UT Chatt 69-3 (-38') and Kent St 71-0 (-49). Now they are angry off a loss to rival Georgia and were left of the proj'd playoff bracket this week. UTEP is 2-8 including a loss to FCS Southern Utah and they are -51 ypg against our #115 sked while Tenn is +167 ypg against our #51 sked. Vols are 7-2 ATS when favored by 35+ under Heupel and will get an extra td or two on Senior Day so we will take the Vols to cover the large line.

Iowa St by 6 over UTAH - The Utes are at home here but come into this game having dropped 6 straight games after a 4-0 start. Utah is putting up just 276 ypg/17 ppg in their L/4 games and last week at Colo put up 272 yds and QB Wilson threw 3 int's in a 49-24 loss. ISU got back in the win column last week vs Cincy 34-17 and while their pass D is holding teams to 51% and 153 ypg (9-14 ratio) the Cyclones run D has allowed 252 ypg (6.3) the L/4 games and have struggled vs running QB's, but with Utah on their 3rd QB we doubt Wilson will run a lot. ISU has QB Becht (63%, 17-7) and RB's Hansen (503, 5.1) plus Sama (449, 5.0). Utah does hold foes to 69 ypg under their season avg (#20). Utah at home will play tough, but the ISU pass D will be the difference here.

UTAH ST by 7 over San Diego St - The home team in this series has failed to cover the L/5 games. Last met last season and Utah St (-2) was at SDSt and won 32-24. USU is back at home after last week's dominant 55-10 win vs Hawaii, where they led 24-3 HT (298-138) and put up 580 yds. USU held Hawaii to 309 yds, which was the first time they held an FBS foe to under 450 yards. SDSt is only avg'g 309 ypg in MW play and are allowing 510 ypg over their L/3 games. Utah St puts up 510 ypg in MW play led by QB Petras (65%, 17-10 ratio) and WR Royals (834, 15.2) plus RB Fasion has 991 yds (5.6). USU also recorded 7 sks last game and were +3 TO's. SDSt is -142 ypg in MW play while USU is +15 ypg and at home in the altitude we like USU by a td.

ARIZONA ST by 7 over BYU - This game is likely a Big 12 title elimination game. BYU had their unbeaten season ended last week by Kansas, as they lost 17-13 despite being +112 yds as the go-ahead td by KU came off of a muffed punt by BYU. ASU is +85 ypg/+13 ppg at home and are led by RB Skatebo who has 1,074 rush yds (5.4) and 31 rec for 448 yds and QB Leavitt is hitting 61% with a 17-4 ratio. BYU does have the #1 pass D and are holding foes to 83 ypg under their avg (#12 FBS) but did allow 269 rush (7.3) to Okla St and 228 rush (5.3) to Kan St plus 181 (6.2) to UCF. Arizona St has played the tougher schedule (#21 vs #37) and with BYU getting their bubble burst last week, we feel like ASU is in a good situation here at home & they get the win.

New Mexico St by 3 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - Last year NMSt on 13-7 (-3) with a 402-346 yd edge. The Aggies have struggled on the road but those games came against most of their toughest competition. Aggies do have a win over LA Tech and covered in their last CUSA game against WKU when they had a 460-413 yd edge but lost by 13. Middle Tenn's 2 wins have come against Kennesaw St & UTEP, both of whom NMSt has not played. Blue Raiders are fresh off a bye and two weeks ago lost to Liberty 37-17 (+11') at home. NMSt is rushing for 185 (4.4) in CUSA play and they have two RB's with over 500 yds while MT is allowing 240 (5.5). MT is rushing for just 80 ypg (2.9). We will take the team that is better in the trenches to win a close game.

CALIFORNIA by 10 over Stanford - It's the first ACC version of 'The Game'. Stanford pulled off a surprising upset LW over L'ville. They trailed 35-21 4Q and after a 2 td w/45 left got a SOD then 2 pen's set up a GW 52 yd fg. Cal suffered an upset loss of their own last week. They were -10 vs Cuse yet never led and trailed 27-7 at half. The Bears need 1 win to get bowl eligible and has SMU on deck. Stanford has lost the last 3 mtgs both SU & ATS but the home team is just 2-6 SU/1-7 ATS. Stanford is -94 ypg vs the ACC and five of their six ACC losses have come by 24 pts or more. Cal is +8 ypg vs the ACC but actually has 1 less ACC win than Stanford and the Cardinal have also ply'd the tougher sked (#11 vs #61). Hard to trust Cal laying 14 pts to their rival so we say take the points.

Fiu by 14 over KENNESAW ST - First mtg. We stil can't believe KSU fired HC Bohannon who started their program 10 years and just pulled an upset over LY's CUSA Champs just a few weeks ago. Rumors of players transferring were swirling yet KSU nearly pulled the upset LW against Sam Houston, only losing 23-17 in OT as 19 pt dogs. FIU has been a disappointing 3-7 but are +5 ypg in CUSA play while KSU is -150. FIU has close losses to 3 of CUSA's top 4, Liberty, SH & Jax St and has wins over LA Tech and NMSt. FIU is laying single-digits but has a big edge at QB with Keyone Jenkins (16-7 ratio) against KSU's Davis Bryson (6-10 ratio) and we are calling for a 2 td margin.

LOUISIANA by 17 over Troy - Last season LA (+16) was tied 17-17 3Q and 24-24 4Q before Troy scored the GW td late 4Q to win 31-24. The Cajuns are off a 24-22 loss to SAIA and need to win their L/2 games to reach the SBC title game. At home LA is +103 ypg/+13 ppg and in SBC play are +101 ypg and are avg'g 451 ypg/32 ppg led by QB Woolldridge (68%, 17-5 ratio) and their top 3 RB's all have 450+ rush yds and avg at least 5.4 ypg. However Woolldridge will miss the rest of the ssn, so Chandler Fields is now QB. Troy is -70 ypg on the road, but have played better over the past 3 games as they have avg'd 473 ypg/32 ppg however LA is holding foes to 38 ypg under their season avg. Off a loss the Cajuns will be re-focused and we like them here by over 2 scores.

Nev has dropped their L/4 gms and are +1 ypg/-12 ppg in their L/4 games while AF is +51 ypg/+3 ppg in their L/4 games. Nev has allowed 203 rush ypg (4.9) in their L/4 games incl allowing 274 rush yds (4.9). Nev is a scrappy team and are off a bye, but this AF team has a ton of momentum and we like the Falcons to pull their 3rd straight outright upset as our Underdog POW!

TCU by 17 over Arizona - TCU enters off a bye and have won 3 of their last 4 games with their only loss coming by 3 at Baylor. Meanwhile Ariz snapped a 5-game losing streak with a 27-3 win over Houston. TCU's offense is putting up 433 ypg in B12 play led by QB Hoover (68%, 22-8) and is avg'g 330 pass ypg. TCU has 4 WR's with 500+ yards and in their last 3 games are putting up 458 ypg/36 ppg. Ariz has the #78 pass D (62%, 17-7) and have allowed 71% and 233 pass ypg over their L/4 games. Ariz QB Fifta hits just 61% with a 15-11 ratio but he and WR McMillian (1136, 16.5) face a TCU pass D that ranks #29 (57%, 12-6). Ariz is just 2-8 ATS this ssn and are -106 ypg/-19 ppg on the road. We like TCU to win here by over 2 td's.

Missouri by 4 over MISSISSIPPI ST - Miss St won the only 2 SEC meetings SU & ATS. Last met in '20 when the game was a pickem but Miss St had a 446-342 yd edge and won 51-32. Mizzou trailed 21-6 and was outgained 267-163 at half LW at SCar but led 4Q before allowing a late td and lost 34-30 (+12). Miss St has covered 4 of their last 5 including as big dogs against Tenn, A&M, UGA & Texas. QB Van Buren has faced some of the FBS' top D's and won't be intimidating by Mizzou whois allowing 388 ypg in SEC play and 424 ypg on the road. Mizzou's only win over a team with a winning record this year came against Vandy of all teams and they were lucky to win that. We think Miss St is improving and capable of keeping it close.

South Alabama by 28 over SOUTHERN MISS - SAla is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS against SMiss and last season the Jags hosted SMiss and led 31-0 HT (402-26) and won 55-3 with a 647-149 yd edge. SAla is off an upset win at Louisiana where they were up 24-3 HT but had to stop a 2-pt try with under 2 min left 4Q to hold on to win 24-22. SMiss is just trying to get the season over with a 1-9 on the season & have yet to beat an FBS team. The L/4 weeks SMiss is -248 ypg/-31 ppg while SAla is +86 ypg/+11 ppg the L/4 gms and overall in SBC play the Jags are +96 ypg/+13 ppg while SMiss is -218 ypg/-25 ppg. SMiss is #133 in offense, #132 in DEF and #124 in ST's and have been outscored 95-6 the L/2 gms. With SAla barely laying over 3 td's, we'll lean strongly with them.

KANSAS ST by 3 over Cincinnati - KSt enters this game off 2 straight disappointing games, as they have lost at Houston and then last week were down 21-0 HT to Ariz St in a 24-14 home loss. Cincy was at Iowa St last week and only trailed 20-17 4Q before 2 late scoring drives for ISU made it a 17 pt loss but they were only -33 yds. Cincy has 4 other losses and 3 are by 1 score, and against Colo were down 8 in the 4Q. In B12 play KSt is +79 ypg while Cincy is +36 ypg and Cincy holds teams to 26 ypg under their avg. Cincy has also allowed just 140 rush ypg (3.3) the L/4 gms and QB Sorsby is hitting 66% with a 16-5 ratio & also has 333 rush (3.8) incl 141 last week! With the line over a td, we like Cincy to keep this game close.

TEXAS by 17 over Kentucky - The only meeting between these two came in 1951 when Bear Bryant was the HC at KY. Texas is 5-1 SU/ATS in their Senior Day including LY when they crushed Texas Tech 57-7 (-14). KY is 5-1 SU/5-0-1 ATS in road finals including LY when they upset #9 L'ville 38-31 (+7). 'Cats are off a 42 pt win over one of the worst FCS teams in Murray St. Texas outgained Ark on the road 315-231 and won 20-10 but were laying 13'. Texas has a huge edge on offense, putting up 450 ypg and 87 ypg more than their foes allow while KY avg 341 ypg and puts up 26 ypg less than their foes allow. TX also holds their foes 136 ypg below their avg which is #1 in the FBS. Longhorns are +136 ypg vs the SEC while KY is -84. Longhorns best SEC win came vs FL who was using a 3rd string W/O QB. 'Cats have ply'd 4 of the SEC's big boys while TX only ply'd UGA and lost by 15. We think Texas wins but laying 3 td's is steep.

Texas Tech by 7 over OKLAHOMA ST - Okla St has won the last 3 meetings. Last met in '22 where Okla St (-9') won 41-31. TT enters this game off a bye and have a chance to regroup after dropping 3 of their 4 previous games. Okla St has dropped 7 straight games and will miss a bowl game for the first time since 2005! Okla St's defense is allowing 515 ypg/37 ppg in B12 play and are allowing foes to gain 114 ypg above their season avg (#131 FBS)! Okla St's run D allows 277 ypg (6.4) and Texas Tech has RB Tahj Brooks (1184, 5.0, 11 td). Okla St has the #74 pass D (59%, 17-10) and TT QB Morton is hitting 62% with a 21-6 ratio and TT has 3 WR's over 450 yards. Okla St is a good home dog, but with nothing left to play for, we'll side with TT by a td.

NORTH TEXAS by 3 over East Carolina - Only prior mtg was back in 1979. EC is now bowl eligible after a late td helped them beat Tulsa 38-31. EC trailed 31-24 in that game before scoring 2 late td's. NT started 5-1 but have lost 4 straight, all to the better CUSA teams in Memphis, Tulane, Army & UTSA. Their run D has reverted back to '23's poor season, giving up 249 (5.3) in their L/4. EC is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS since firing HC Houston and promoted DC Blake Harrell. We like how EC has pulled together since Houston's firing and they won't roll over but NT has only lost to his 5 toughest foes and still need a win to get bowl eligible so we will call for NT to win a close game.

TEXAS ST by 28 over Georgia St - TXSt has lost 4 of the L/6 meetings with GA State. After losing B2B games to ODU and Louisiana, TXSt beat ULM by 21 pts and SMiss by 52 pts in the L/2 games. GA State has lost 7 straight games, but 4 of those losses are 7 pts. GSt was blown out in their last road game at JMU 38-7 and were down 21 pts to UConn before coming back. GSt is allowing 231 rush ypg (5.5) the L/4 games and TXSt's run game is avg'g 239 ypg (5.9) the L/4 games. GAST also has the #111 pass D and TXSt QB McCloud is hitting 70% with a 25-8 ratio. TXSt holds foes to 40 ypg under their avg and in SBC play are allowing just 322 ypg. TXSt is +161 ypg in SBC play while GAST is -62 ypg. At home we like the Bobcats to pour it on & win by 4 td's.

UAB by 3 over Rice - Former CUSA rivals meet in an AAC matchup for the first time. Rice actually won the last 2 mtgs as 10 & 23' pt dogs but this time it's Rice who is favored by 6' on the road. Rice is 3-7 but +28 ypg vs AAC and does have closer than expected losses to Memphis and Tulane. UAB is 2-8 and -65 ypg vs the AAC. LW they trailed Memphis 32-18 4Q but the game got away late and they lost by 35. UAB did lead UConn by 17 at half two weeks ago but lost by 8. Rice lost to that same UConn team by 7 points. We couldn't imagine laying 6' points on the road considering Rice's 10-39 SU road record s/'16 while UAB is 35-9 SU at home since '16. We think the wrong team is favored.

ARKANSAS by 14 over Louisiana Tech - Ark won the last meeting in '16 by just 1 point. Hogs are 9-16 ATS vs Non-P4 foes since '15 and are in a tough SEC sandwich, coming off a hard fought 10 pt loss to Texas and they have rival Missouri on deck. LT is 4-6 and just upset WKU on the road

12-7. The Bulldogs D is allowing just 302 ypg and holding foes 48 ypg below their avg. They were +20' yet led NCST 17-6 at half and only lost by 10 earlier this year. Ark was '22' against UAB back in Sept and trailed 17-0 2Q before pulling out a 10 pt win. Hogs are 7-13 ATS as 20+ favorite and none of LT's losses are by more than 10 pts. LT has the defense to keep it closer than expected.

AUBURN by 3 over Texas A&M - Home team has won & covered L/3 in this series. Aub is 4-6 but coming off a 48-14 win over ULM (-24) and the Tigers are +124 ypg and +92 vs the SEC. A&M is 8-2 after beating NMST 38-3 (-39') last week. The Aggies are +68 ypg but only +19 vs the SEC. Aub's D has held their L/3 foes under 300 ypg and they are giving up just 89 rush ypg (2.7) in their L/4. A&M lost star RB Le'Veon Moss (765, 6.3) for the ssn. Tigers QB Payton Thorne has an 18-7 ratio including 8-2 vs the SEC. The Tigers have the edge at RB with Jarquez Hunter (1015, 7.0) and WR with KeAndre Lambert-Smith (761, 19.0). Their D is allowing 305 ypg and holding foes 79 ypg below their avg while A&M allows 345 ypg and holds foes 43 ypg below their avg. A&M has a huge game on deck against Texas while Auburn needs to win their L/2 to reach a bowl. Lots of reasons to like the Tigers here so we are calling for the upset.

Baylor by 13 over HOUSTON - The Bears enter this matchup on a hot streak, winning their L/4 games (3-0-1 ATS) and their offense is humming during this win streak, putting up 526 ypg/46 ppg led by QB Robertson, who is hitting 61% with a 20-4 ratio and RB's Washington (699, 6.1) and Pendergrass (463, 6.2) are both playing well as the BU rush offense is avg'g 260 ypg (7.0) the L/4 games. UH did have wins vs Utah and Kan St at home, but last week at Ariz they were beat 27-3. UH only puts up 288 yds in B12 play and their 2 QB's have comb'd for an 8-12 ratio. Baylor has had their issues with defense, but we don't see UH's offense being able to keep up and like Baylor here by 2 scores.

Usc by 7 over UCLA - These cross-town rivals now meet as B10 foes. USC still needs 1 more win for a bowl, while UCLA needs to win their L/2 games for a bowl. USC is off a 28-20 win vs Nebraska where they went to QB Maiava and he threw for 259 yds and a 3 td's (1 int). UCLA lost at Wash last week 31-19, but scored a td with 9 sec left 4Q to make it look closer. USC's offense is avg'g 438 ypg and are putting up 100 ypg more than their foes allow (#7 FBS!) and their DEF holds foes to 26 ypg under their avg. UCLA does allow just 341 ypg in B10 play, but their offense puts up just 321 ypg/19 ppg. UCLA also has the #90 pass D and USC avg's 288 pass ypg. USC has 5 losses all by 7 pts or less, so are better than their record & we think they are the better team here.

LSU by 3 over Vanderbilt - LSU has won their L/9 mtgs by 20.3 ppg (5-3-1 ATS) but they haven't met since '20. Tigers playoff hopes went up in smoke last week when they lost 27-16 at Florida. Now they host a scrappy Vandy squad that has already upset Bama at home and KY and Auburn on the road. They've also had close losses to Texas and Mizzou by just 3 pts each. LSU has lost 3 straight including at home to Bama 42-13 (+2). Vandy is fresh off a bye so Diego Pavia should be healthier. This is a night game in Baton Rouge but with LSU's main goal gone and what is normally an SEC doormat in town, we don't think the crowd will be as lively. LSU is 17-2 SU at home under Kelly so we won't call for the upset but Vandy has proven they will keep it close.

Boise St by 17 over WYOMING - Since 2015 Boise is 8-1 SU against Wyoming but have failed to cover 6 of the 9 meetings. The L/5 games have all gone 'Under' the Vegas total with an avg of 35 points scored. Boise is 9-1 on the season & in prime position to get a playoff bid. Boise is +104 ypg/+20 ppg in MW play while Wyoming is -28 ypg/-2 ppg. The L/4 games Wyoming has allowed 475 ypg incl 246 rush ypg (8.0) and here they face RB Jeanty (1893, 7.4, 26 td) and QB Madsen is hitting 64% (19-3 ratio). Boise's pass D is #107 (63%, 19-6) and allowing 267 ypg, but Wyoming is hitting just 50% with a 9-10 ratio. The line here is over 3 td's and Boise has won only 1 MW game by more than 3 td's, so we'll call for Wyoming to keep this game within the number.

Washington St by 14 over OREGON ST - This is the 'Pac-2' title game. WSU enters 8-2 and are +29 ypg/+11 ppg on the season, but did just drop a game at NMEx 38-35 where they allowed 534 yds incl 360 rush (7.3)! Oregon St started 4-1 but have now dropped 5 straight games and over the past 4 games are -129 ypg/-21 ppg, but did take on UNLV, Cal, SJSt and Air Force. At home this ssn Oregon St is 3-3 SU/1-5 ATS and are just +7 ypg at home. Gabarri Johnson took over at QB last week but the offense is avg'g just 304 ypg/11 ppg in the L/4 gms. OSU does struggle to stop the run (183, 5.3) and are rushing for 182 (4.8) led by QB Mateer (695, 4.8). OSU is on a slide, and we like the Cougars to win this game by 2 scores.

Alabama by 10 over OKLAHOMA - Bama meets OK for the first time since the '18 CFB Semifinal won by Bama 45-34 (-13'). Oklahoma did win the previous 3 meetings though. Since Bama's loss at Tennessee, the Crimson Tide have won 3 straight by 34, 29 & 45 points. OK needs 1 win to reach a bowl and they have LSU on deck. Sooners are fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they led Missouri 23-16 4Q but lost by 7, giving up the GW td on a fumble return with :22 left. This is the first time that OK has been a double-digit home dog since 1997 when the Sooners upset Donovan McNabb's Syracuse 36-34 (+11)! The Sooners did lead Ole Miss 14-10 at half and QB Jackson Arnold has been better since his benching. OK has won 11 straight on Sr Day and we can't pass up the chance to take the Sooners getting 13' at home so we say take the points.

4★ MIAMI over New England - MIA enters this game riding a 2 game win streak and looked strong a week ago in their 34-19 win vs the Raiders where QB Tagovailoa threw for 288 yds (78%, 3-0 ratio). MIA is 5-1 SU/ATS vs NE since 2021 and MIA has won & covered their L/4 games vs NE here in Miami. IND went back to QB Richardson last week and the Colts held the Jets to 253 yds and QB Richardson was 20-30 and scored 2 rush td's. IND's pass D has allowed 71% completions and 248 ypg over the L/4 games and DET QB Goff is hitting 73% and a 20-9 ratio and just threw for 412 yds (80%, 4-0 ratio). IND's run D does allow 143 ypg (4.4) but DET's 1-2 punch at RB with Montgomery and Gibbs is the most effective RB tandem in the league that avg's 152 ypg (4.7) and both RB's are good receivers (44 catches comb'd). DET's defense is allowing 328 ypg overall & over the L/4 games allowing 311 ypg/14 ppg and are +24 ppg. IND is -54 ypg on the season and avg just 306 ypg the L/4 gms. QB Richardson also has a 5-7 ratio and is hitting just 48%, and DET's secondary has 13 int's on the season. DET could also have the crowd edge here, so there's no real home edge. DET is 8-2 ATS the L/2 years as an away favorite and we see no reason not to back DET here.

2★ Denver over LAS VEGAS - Coming into this season DEN has lost 8 straight games vs the Raiders (1-7 ATS) but this season DEN snapped that streak, winning 34-18 at home despite being -41 yds as they were +3 TO's incl a pick-six! DEN snapped a 2-game skid with a 38-6 win over ATL at home (4★ top player late phone winner!!) where they held a 400-226 yds edge and QB Nix threw for a career-best 307 yds & 4 td's! LV meanwhile dropped to 2-8 and have now lost 6 games in a row. Over the L/4 weeks LV is avg'g just 273 ypg and here they face a DEN defense holding foes to 52 ypg under their avg (#4 NFL) and give up just 289 ypg. LV's OL paves the way for just 75 rush ypg (3.5) and have allowed 33 sks, and here face a DEN rush D allowing just 76 ypg (3.1) the L/4 gms and overall have 39 sks incl 8 the past 2 games. PIT won despite not scoring a td as K Boswell made 6 fg's and benefitted from +2 TO's and 2 missed fg's by BAL. CLE was tied 14-14 with the Saints entering the 4Q but allowed 21 straight pts and lost 35-14 while allowing 473 yds incl 214 rush yds (7.6). CLE's offense is getting held to 62 ypg under what their foes allow (#30 NFL) and are putting up just 89 rush ypg (4.0) and the OL has allowed 46 sks. PIT's defense is holding tms to 30 ypg under their season avg (#8 NFL) and allow just 91 rush ypg (4.1). **Call the office on Thur after Noon for the Marquee Winner!**

Kansas City by 17 over CAROLINA - KC dropped their first game of the ssn last week at BUF where they were held to a ssn-low 259 yds where QB Mahomes threw 2 more int's (15-11 ratio this ssn). CAR is off a bye, and actually is riding a 2 game win streak, but those were against the Saints and Giants. All 7 of CAR's losses are by at last 10 pts and their L/4 losses have been by 23 ppg. CAR only puts up 281 ypg & over their L/4 gms that is down to 254 ypg. KC is allowing just 298 ypg and are holding tms to 61 ypg under their ssn avg (#2 NFL). CAR is allowing tms to pass for 227 ypg (69%) and are -114 ypg/-12 ppg at home while KC is +31 ypg on the road. KC is 7-2 ATS since 2022 off a SU loss and CAR is 0-3 ATS as a DD dog the L/2 ssn's. We like the Chiefs to bounce back off a loss and win by over 2 td's.

Minnesota by 4 over CHICAGO - The Vikings are 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS against the Bears since 2021. The home team is just 1-7 ATS in the L/8 meetings. MIN is on the road for a 3rd straight week and have won the first 2 games. The Vikings are led by their defense, that is holding teams to 263 ypg/16 ppg over the L/4 games and are allowing just 66 rush ypg (2.9) over the L/4 games. CHI nearly broke their losing streak vs GB last week but had a fg blocked on the final play. QB Williams played better last week, hitting 74% and threw for 231 yds. The Vikings get after the QB (35 sks) and Williams has been sacked 40 times incl 18 times the last 3 games! CHI just allowed 260 pass yds to GB last week & now face WR's Addison and Jefferson and QB Darnold is hitting 70% the L/4 games. We'll lean slightly with MIN here, but this should be a lower-scoring game.

WASHINGTON by 14 over Dallas - Since 2021 DAL is 5-1 SU/ATS against the Commanders. WAS comes in having lost their L/2 games and have been held to 242 yds and 264 yds but come in with extra rest, having played last Thur in Philly. In come the Cowboys though who have dropped 5 straight games (0-5 ATS) and are on short rest after a 34-10 loss on MON night vs HOU. DAL's pass D is allowing 71% the L/4 games so we expect QB Daniels and the WAS pass attack to get going here and Daniels had extra time to prep and rest. DAL is also -79 ypg/-16 ppg the L/4 gms. WAS at home is allowing just 263 ypg and are +138 ypg at home and are 4-1 SU/ATS at home. Their defense is allowing 335 ypg and they do have 28 sks on the season. DAL's OL paves the way for just 82 rush ypg (3.5) and have allowed 11 sacks the L/3 games. Tampa Bay by 7 over NY GIANTS - TB is off a bye and that came at the right time as the Bucs had dropped 4 straight prior to the bye, but 3 of those games were within 6 pts. TB could be getting WR Evans back here, which would help a pass attack that has only put up 189 and 105 the L/2 gms. Meanwhile NYG is making a switch at QB to Tommy DeVito, who threw for 1,101 yds (64%, 8-3 ratio) last season. NYG is just 2-8 on the season and are on a 5 game SU/ATS losing streak. NYG does allow opposing QB's to hit 70% and TB QB Mayfield is #3 NFL with a 70.6% completion percentage & 24 td passes. TB is likely without OL Wirfs, which is a big loss and NYG does have 36 sacks. TEN dropped to 2-8 on the season and failed to put up over 300 yds for the 8th time in 10 games. For the season TEN is +17 ypg but are #31 in the NFL in TO margin at -11 while HOU is +8 in TO's. TEN has also allowed 33 sks incl 12 the L/2 games and HOU's pass rush has 34 sks incl 5 on MON night. HOU holds tms to 297 ypg and their offense is more potent and less TO prone than TEN.
