Dating back to 1976 SJSt has never been a favorite vs Stanford until this season. Stanford cannot reach a bowl while SJSt is already at 6 wins. While SJSt had issues throwing the ball last week vs UNLV (4-22 for 81 yds) in a rainstorm, they are still avg'g 320 pass ypg and take on a Stanford pass D that ranks #122 (66%, 27-8) and the Spartans have two stellar WR's in Nash (1291, 13.4, 14 td) and Lockhart (915, 19.1). Stanford does only put up 314 ypg/19 ppg on the road and SJSt at home is +36 g. We think SJSt's pass attack will be the difference here & like them by a td.

IOWA by 7 over Nebraska - Since 2015 lowa is 8-1 SU against the Huskers. Iowa is back home & they have been rock solid there in B10 play, as they are 3-0 SU/ATS winning by an avg of 27 ppg and were +96 ypg. The Huskers finally picked up their 6th win to reach a bowl, so their goal for the season has been accomplished as they beat Wisky 44-25 (+66 yds, +14 fd's) as QB Raiola was 28-38 for 293 & 1 td. Neb has a strong defense, holding foes to 51 ypg under their ssn avg (#32) and allow just 111 rush ypg (3.6) but here face RB Johnson (1492, 6.7, 21 td) and an lowa rush attack avg'g 203 ypg (5.4) in B10 play. Iowa holds tms to 46 ypg under their avg and have the #31 pass D. Iowa is on a 20-2 SU run in November games and we like that run to continue here.

GEORGIA by 14 over Georgia Tech - UGA is 19-3 SU/14-7-1 ATS since '01. GT has covered the last the conductive the strong that the strong the strong

two and last year they were +24 but only lost 31-23. Just like last year, UGA has the SEC Title game on deck and the Dawgs are off an easy 59-21 win over UMass. GT is 8-3 ATS vs ranked foes under Brent Key including an outright upset over #4 Miami earlier this month. They get extra rest coming off their Thurs night win over NCSt. Dawgs are laying almost 3 td's and they are on an 0-6 ATS run as a favorite of 14+ points. We will go with the underdog Jackets who have played this game tough the last two years. UCF by 3 over Utah - Both teams come into season finale on a low note as Utah has dropped 7 straight games, but 5 of those 7 losses came by 8 pts or less. Despite being just 1-7 in B12 play Utah is only -28 ypg/-5 ppg. UCF has won just 1 of their last 8 gms and are off an upset 31-21 loss at WVU. Since changing their DC UCF is allowing just 280 ypg and Utah's offense is putting up just 265 ypg over their last 4 games. UCF has turned to QB Rizk and he is hitting 68% with a 5-1 ratio, but does face a Utah pass D ranked #4 (53%, 14-10 ratio). Utah did lose QB Wilson and it could be Luke Bottari at QB, so the offense would be RB Bernard (922, 5.3). The line has UCF by over a td and we think Utah's defese will keep them in this game.

COLORADO ST by 1 over Utah St - Utah St has won 5 straight SU in this series and have pulled the

outright upset in 2 of the L/3 mtgs. USU has now won 3 of their L/4 games after losing their F/6 FBS games and last week delievered a 4★ LP winner for us as they fell behind 13-0 vs SDSt 1H but then scored 41 straight in a 41-20 win. CSU saw their MW title game chances take a big hit last week, as they fell to Fresno 28-22 despite holding a 422-343 yd edge. CSU is +20 ypg in MW play, while USU is actually +25 ypg despite a 3-4 MW record (CSU 5-1). USU's offense is avg § 507 ypg/39 ppg and Bryson Barnes came in at QB and was 13-15 and 3 td's plus ran for 193 (12.9, 1 td). With how strong USU is playing down the stretch, we like their offense to keep them in this game and take it down to the wire. ATURDAY NOVEMBER 30th

ARMY by 3 over Utsa - Army has won 3 of the L/4 mtgs including LY 37-29 (-8). The home team is 0-4 SU/ATS in this series. UTSA clinched a bowl LW by beating Temple 51-27 (-16'). UTSA never trailed but it was only 31-24 3Q before they pulled away. We won our 4 * Key Selection and LPS going against Army last week in their 49-14 (+14) loss to Notre Dame. Army is in uncharted territory with the AAC Title game on deck vs Tulane. Army is +109 ypg but their sked strength is dead last in the country and they have just 1 win over a team that is currently bowl elig. UTSA is +121 ypg vs our #111 sked and they also have just 1 win over a team that is currently bowl elig yet Army is laying over a td. Owen McCown has really turned a corner for UTSA (23-7 ratio) and we think UTSA can keep this within a fg. CINCINNATI by 3 over Tcu - After starting 3-3 incl a loss to HOU, TCU has now won 4 of their L/5 games and their last 2 wins are by 25 and 21 pts. Cincy meanwhile has now dropped 4 straight games incl losing by 17 and 26 pts each of the L/2 gms after starting 5-2. Over the L/4 gms Cincy is -15 ppg and here they face a TCU team +48 ypg/+11 ppg and are putting up 456 ypg over their L/4 games. TCU is off two blowout wins at home vs bottom B12 teams while Cincy is off two losses on the road vs upper-tier B12 teams. TCU will be playing in cold and possibly snowy conditions, which are less than ideal for a passing team that only avg's 113 rush (3.7). Cincy does have a home win vs Ariz St and are +108 ypg at home and have a talented 1-2 punch at RB with Kiner (1043, 5.8) and Pryor (407, 7.8). We like TCU to get the outright upset at home.

Coastal Carolina by 3 over GEORGIA ST - The home team in this series is 0-7 SU/0-6-1 ATS. Coastal is sitting at 5 wins and needs a 6th win for a bowl while GSt will be trying to play the role of

spoiler as they only have 3 wins. GSt did just pull a massive upset last week at TXSt (+20') 52-44 with QB Veilleux throwing for 285 & 3 td. Coastal has had some success running the ball this ssn (170, 4.8) and can do that here vs a GSt run defense allowing 224 ypg (5.4) vs SBC foes. GSt also has the #108 pass D (63%, 19-7) and CC QB Vasko is capable of putting up good passing numbers. Coastal has only allowed 338 ypg over the L/3 gms & has 8 sacks. CC lost their last 2 games in large part to being -6 TO's. We like CC to get win #6 here.

South Carolina by 3 over CLEMSON - This game takes on all-new meaning with both teams sitting on the playoff bubble. Clemson is 8-1 SU/5-3 ATS in this series since '14 including LY's 16-7 (-7') win where the Tigers held SC to a ssn low 169 yds. SC actually won LTH 31-30 (+14). Both teams are off easy wins over FCS foes. SC has won 5 straight (4-1 ATS) and are +200 ypg in their L/4 Clemson has won 3 straight and they are +79 ypg in their L/4 wks. Clemson did lose to L'ville at home while SC has wins at OK, KY & Vandy and only lost by 2 at Bama. SC has 39 sacks this year and Clemson has been missing as many as 3 starting OL and gave up 11 sks in their L/3 vs FBS foes. This is by far the toughest D that Clemson has faced since they lost to UGA in the opener and we think the Gamecocks talented Dline is the difference in a close win.

Pittsburgh by 3 over BOSTON COLLEGE - Pitt was on a 4 game losing streak last year but still

beat BC 24-16 w/a 404-325 yd edge. Pitt started this ssn 7-0 but once again enter on a 4 game losing streak. Last week Pitt lost QB Eli Holstein to injury in the 1Q and Pitt was no match for Louisville in a 37-9 (+7') loss. LW was the first time since their opener that BC outgained an FBS foe. BC had a 420-212 yd edge and they beat NC 41-21 (+2'). Pitt has 36 sacks this year and BC has allowed 26. Pitt bkp QB Nate Yarnelll looked good when they nearly upset Clemson and Pitt has a huge ST's edge (#27 vs #128) so we look for the desperate Panthers squad to circle the wagons just like last year. NORTH CAROLINA by 1 over NC State - NCSt is 12-5 SU in this series with 3 straight wins since '07 and the underdog is 19-6 ATS with 15 outright upsets since '98! NC is 6-5 and just had their 3 game win streak snapped by BC 41-21 (-2') and outgained 420-212. NCSt needs a win to get bowl elig. The Wolfpack have lost 2 straight but nearly upset GTech LW, giving up the GW td with :22 left and lost 30-29 (+9). Wolfpack are +3' in a rivalry that has frequent upsets. We think NC is the better team and they are out for double-revenge but we will go with the series trend and lean with the underdog. Florida by 21 over FLORIDA ST - Last year was a battle of bkp QB's and Florida blew a 12-0 lead and FSU won 24-15 (-6'). 'Noles are just 2-9 SU/3-8 ATS but did win last week 41-7 (-31) against 1-11 Char Southern. Now they take on a surging Florida team, coming off upset wins over both LSU and Ole Miss. The Gators nearly upset Tenn on the road and were on their way to upsetting Georgia until QB Lagway got hurt and missed the Texas game. Florida did get outgained in each of their L/4 (-73 ypg L/4) but FSU is -116 ypg on the ssn and -134 in their L/4. FL has a huge edge on offense, putting up 376 ypg while FSU avg just 271 and has yet to hit 300 yds vs an FBS foe. Over 2 td's is a lot for a rivalry game but we can't lean with the 'Noles who have six losses by 15 points or more this year! NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 7 over Central Michigan - CMich is 8-2 SU/9-1 ATS in this series and the dog 8-2 ATS with 6 outright upsets. This is Jim McElwain's last game at CMich after announcing his retirement. The Chips just upset rival WMich 16-14 last week and finished w/a 307-184 yd edge. NIU is just 4-5 since their upset win over Notre Dame. LW the Huskies trailed Miami, OH 17-0 2Q and were outgained 250-81 in the 1H. HC Hammock is 5-16 ATS as a home favorite while CMich is 13-7-1 ATS as a double-digit dog. CMich is -76 vs the MAC while NIU is +65 and NIU has ply'd a slightly tougher sked (#109 vs #125). CMich has the ST's edge and the technical edge as a good underdog playing a poor home favorite. We think CMich plays inspired for McElwain so we say take the points. North Texas by 17 over TEMPLE - NT started the season 5-1 then their defense tanked against the run and the Mean Green have lost 5 straight but all of those were against the better AAC teams. Temple will be staying home for bowl season at 3-8. LW was their 1st game under Interim HC Everett Withers and they lost at UTSA 51-27 (+16'). NT is +2 ypg vs the AAC while Temple is -139. Against 6 common foes, Temple is -17.8 ppg & -147 ypg. NT is a only -2.7 ppg and -19 ypg. NT has a big edge on offense, avg 494 ypg while Temple only avg 303. Owls run D is allowing 254 (6.0) in AAC play and NT does their best work when they run the ball well. NT dealing with cold weather is a concern but they have a big motivation edge, needing a win to get bowl eligible. We think NT wins by over 2 td's. Tennessee by 7 over VANDERBILT - Tenn is 5-0 SU in series with their closest win coming by 18 points but only 2-3 ATS. The home team is 0-5 ATS in the series. Vols had yet another slow start last week, tied 0-0 after 1Q vs UTEP then scored td's on 5 of their next 6 poss's and won 56-0 (-41'). Not only has Vandy upset Bama, KY and Auburn, they've also stayed within a td against Mizzou, Texas and LSU. Tenn is +172 ypg but only +33 vs the SEC. Vandy is -19 ypg and -80 ypg vs the SEC but Vandy has played a tougher sked (#22 vs #67). 'Dores are +11 and they are 7-0 as a dog of 7+ points. QB lamaleava has only thrown 5 td passes in SEC play while Vandy's Pavia has 11 td's passes vs the SEC. Tenn has pressure to just win the game and Vandy loves playing as the underdog so we think this will be a close game. **Uconn by 14 over UMASS -** UConn is 6-3 SU in this series since 1998 and they've covered 4 of 6 as FBS foes. Five of the last six have gone Under the total. UConn is playing their 3rd straight road game. Last week they were outgained 538-352 by Syracuse but covered as 10' pt dogs, losing 31-24. UMass put up 209 yds in the 1H at Georgia last week and only trailed 28-14. The Minutemen

covered as 42 pt dogs, losing 59-21 in their first game under Interim HC Shane Montgomery. UConn is 3-0 as an AF under Mora. The Huskies have won 3 straight while UMass has lost 3 straight. Unlike Both of UMass' wins this year were against FCS teams and the Minutemen are -69 ypg vs FBS foes while UConn has 6 wins over FBS foes and is +11 ypg vs FBS foes. UMass normally plays teams that look ahead to conference games but UConn will be fully focused and win by 2 td's.

Miami,FI by 6 over SYRACUSE - Miami has won the last 6 meetings but Cuse covered last 2 back in '03 & '17. This is only their 2nd tm meeting as ACC foes. Miami is 10-1 and ranked #8 but they've been been collecting misleading scores each week. They trailed by DD's in the 2H vs VT, Cal, and Duke and they lost to GA Tech three weeks ago. Last week UM only led WF 20-14 at half then scored 3 td's in the final 7:58 and covered as 23' pt favorites. Cuse enters 8-3 with two of their losses were by 6 or less. QB McCord has bounced back since his 5 int performance against Pitt with a 7-1 ratio in their L/4. Cuse's D is holding foes 15 ypg below their avg and they only allow 204 pass ypg but they are only #99 in our pass D Efficiency rankings (17-9). Miami does have the ACC title game on deck and they've let their opponent stick around in nearly every ACC game so we will lean with the dog. VIRGINIA TECH by 11 over Virginia - VT has won 18 of the last 19 in the Commonwealth Clash. Both teams sit at 5 wins and need to win for bowl elig. VT has been battling injuries during a 3 game losing streak. They were w/o QB Kyron Drones last week at Duke then bkp Collin Schlee was hurt so they went to rFr William "Pop" Watson and he hit 12 of 25 for 146 yds and an int in VT's 31-28 (-3) loss to Duke. UVA has lost five of their last 6 with four of those losses coming by 17 points or more. Last week they were outgained 434-173 and lost 33-7 to SMU (+11). Cavs are -86 ypg vs the ACC while VT is -14. VT has the edge in all 3 phases including ST's (#25 vs #83) and has ply'd a tougher sked (#17 vs #29). If the Hokies get healthy then they should beat their rival yet again. WESTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Eastern Michigan - Both teams need to win this game to be bowl eligible. EM is the dog for the 26th straight year against WM yet the Eagles are 17-8 ATS and prior to LY's loss they had won 4 straight from '19-'22. WM started 5-3 but they've lost their last 3 and

three of their 4 MAC wins have come against the bottom of the conference. ÉM only has 2 MAC wins against non bowl teams but they do have a great win over Jax St. In MAC play EM is +3 ypg while WMich is -5. EM does have a win over Central Mich who just beat WMich and the Broncos were outgained 307-184. EMich is 30-10-1 ATS as an away dog since 2016. Both teams will be giving max effort so we expect a tight game and as usual Eastern Michigan keeps it closer than expected. Marshall by 1 over JAMES MADISON - JMU can play the role of spoiler here as Marshall needs a win to reach the SBC title game. JMU dropped their 3rd game of the season last week at App St where held the yds edge (400-361) but were -2 TO's and lost 34-20. MU picked up their 5th straight win at ODU as they won 42-35. RB Turner was back but it was QB Braxton who led the way with 140 rush and 210 passing (3-0 ratio). JMU does play much better at home (5-0 SU) and are +152

ypg/+29 ppg. These tms have faced the same 7 common SBC foes and JMU is +80 ypg/+8 ppg while Marshall is even ypg and +12 ppg. Marshall has played the tougher schedule (#100 vs #127) and are +8 TO's the L/4 gms, plus are allowing just 178 pass ypg (53%) in the L/4 gms. This will be a close game but we'll side with the Herd to win & get to the SBC title game.

Uab by 1 over CHARLOTTE - UAB lost their first 6 vs FBS foes but they've now won 2 of their last 4 with blowout wins over Tulsa and Rice. Both of those wins came at home and the Blazers are 0-11 SU/4-7 ATS on the road under Dilfer. CLT won a battle of Interim HC's last week with Tim Brewster leading CLT to a 39-27 (-3) win over FAU. QB Deshawn Purdue threw for a ssn high 396 yds and 3 td's. Now he faces a UAB Pass D that allows just 177 ypg but is #71 in our Pass D efficiency rankings (57%, 17-8). 49ers -92 ypg while UAB is -9. CLT is in their last game with a lame duck coaching staff while UAB has yet to make a change and wants positive momentum. Finally winning a road game would do just that for UAB so we are calling for the Blazers to eek out a close win and their ST's edge (#54 vs #80) will be the difference.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 3 over Appalachian St - Rivarly game with both teams playing for something. App needs a win to reach a bowl while a GSthrn with & a Marshall loss would put the Eagles in the SBC title game. GSthrn's cover streak was broken last season (had covered 5 straight) as they lost at App St 55-27. App St got a big home upset last week vs JMU with QB Aguilar throwing for 2 td's and App St being +2 TO's. GSthrn got a 26-6 win at Coastal as threy held CC to 280 yds and were +3 TO's. GSthrn has the huge ST's edge (#21 vs #118) and QB French (65%, 15-7) will face the #125 pass D. This will be a hard-fought game & we'll put it right at the Vegas line

face the #125 pass D. This will be a hard-fought game & we'll put it right at the Vegas line. **Duke by 1 over WAKE FOREST** - The home team is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS in this series and the underdog is 5-2 ATS with 4 outright upsets. Last year Duke was -7 but only won 24-21 on a 26 yd fg as time expired. WF is 4-7 and will not be bowling for the 2nd straight year. Last week Duke ply'd a shorthanded VTech team and won 31-28 (+3). WF only trailed Miami 20-14 4Q and allowed 3 td's in the final 7:58 to give up a front door cover. Duke had a similar game vs Miami where they led by 11 3Q but lost by 22. WF has ply'd the tougher sked (#45 vs #62). The series favors the home underdog and we like WF to keep this very close. Duke has the motivation edge but WF will keep this very close.

Vlech team and won 31-28 (+3). Wh only trailed Miamir 2U-14 4Q and allowed 3 td's in the final 7:58 to give up a front door cover. Duke had a similar game vs Miami where they led by 11 3Q but lost by 22. WF has ply'd the tougher sked (#45 vs #62). The series favors the home underdog and we like WF to keep this very close. Duke has the motivation edge but WF will keep this very close.

OHIO ST by 17 over Michigan - After winning 15 of 16 mtgs from 2004-2019, Mich has won and covered the L/3 meetings. Ohio St is certainly out for revenge and do have the edge on offense with QB Howard (74%, 26-6 ratio) and WR's Smith (899, 17.3) and Egbuka (692, 12.4) and the Mich pass D only ranks #54 (63%, 17-9). OSU is rushing for 159 (4.6) the L/4 games but last week vs Indy had just 115 (4.0) and Mich's DLine is strong as they allow just 94 rush ypg (3.1) and have 10 sks the L/2 gms & here face a less than 100% OSU OL. Mich does hold foes to 71 ypg under their avg & have played the tougher sked (#10 vs #44). OSU will win the game, but with the line being almost 3 td's & Mich playing strong defense, we think they keep it within the number.

ARKANSAS ST by 3 over Old Dominion - Ark St enters this game 7-4 on the season, with all 4 losses coming on the road vs strong opponents. They are 5-0 SU at home and last week they cashed a 2★ Power Sweep play that was upgraded to a 4★ late phone play as they beat ULM 28-21. ODU cannot reach a bowl after their 42-35 loss to Marshall at home. Ark St has put up 413 ypg the L/4 gms incl 211 rush (5.0) led by Cross (548, 5.6) and Wallace (533, 4.3) and QB Raynor is hitting 65% and ODU has the #74 pass D (61%, 19-11) and have allowed 233 (4.9) and 259 (6.2) rushing in their L/2 gms (both losses). Ark St is home dog, but play much better at home and we like them to pull the outright home upset here.

Rutgers by 1 over MICHIGAN ST - Mich St enters this matchup needing a win to reach a bowl, while Rutgers already has 6 wins. Rutgers does have the edge on offense as Mich St only avg's 330 ypg/18 ppg in B10 play and they were outgained 338-293 vs lowly Purdue at home, winning by only 7 pts. Mich St does have the stronger defense, holding teams to 34 ypg under their avg and over the L/4 gms Mich St is holding teams to 339 ypg and Rutgers has allowed 400+ yards in 5 of their L/6 games. Rutgers RB Monangai (1150, 5.1, 12 td) is their top offensive threat and QB Kaliakmanis has a 16-6 ratio, while MSU QB Chiles has just a 12-12 ratio and the OL has allowed 32 sacks. This is a toss-up game in our eyes and we'll side with Rutgers to win close.

FIU by 14 over Middle Tennessee - Two tms staying home for bowl season meet. MT has won the last 5 mtgs but those were under Rick Stockstill. The visitor is 1-7 ATS and the Over is 14-5 since 2005. MT is 1-4 SU/2-3 ATS and -175 ypg on the road. All 3 of FIU's wins have come in Pitbull Stadium. The Panthers are 4-1 ATS and +13 ypg at home. MT is -78 ypg vs the CUSA while FIU is +10. FIU has a solid edge on D, hold foes to 370 ypg and 11 ypg below thier avg while MT allows 448 ypg and 74 ypg more than their foes avg. You have a good home team with a big edge on D laying single digits against a bad road team. Easy enough, we have MT by 2 td's.

BÝU by 14 over Houston - BYU enters this game needing a win and some help to reach the B12 title game, while Houston is at 4 wins and cannot reach a bowl. UH struggling on offense, only avg'g 282 ypg/12 ppg in B12 play and are -70 ypg in B12 play and face a BYU defense that is holding foes to 73 ypg under their season avg (#16), are #1 in our pass D rankings (53%, 11-18)and are +25 ypg/+8 ppg in conf play. The BYU offense is up against a Houston defense holding foes to 82 ypg under their avg (#14). BYU does have a great home crowd and HOU will have to deal with the elevation and cold temps. We like BYU here to get the win by 2 td's.

CLA by 14 over Fresno St - Fresno has won the L/4 mtgs. Last met in '21 and Fresno (+11) cameback to win 40-37. Fresno snapped a 2 game losing streak & won their 6th game LW, clinching a bowl, while UCLA cannot make a bowl, but still want to finish strong. UCLA is +57 ypg the L/4 gms and pulled a home upset of lowa and nearly pulled the upset last week vs USC. Fresno is -77 ypg the L/4 gms and overall have played the weaker schedule (UCLA #1, Fresno #97) and the UCLA D is holding foes to 53 ypg under their avg and Fresno is putting up 65 ypg under what their foes allow (#121). This line is single digits and we think UCLA shuts down Fresno & win by 2 td's. Usf by 14 over RICE - USF won the only prior meeting 42-29 (+2') last year. USF's offense has put

Ust by 14 over RICE - USF won the only prior meeting 42-29 (+2') last year. USF's offense has put up over at least 35 pts in 4 of their L/5 and avg 533 ypg in their L/4. The Bulls got bwl eligible last week by beating Tulsa 63-30 (-17'). Now they play a Rice team with a lame duck coaching staff that just lost 40-14 at UAB. Rice has a big edge on D but USF has big edges on Offense and ST's. USF is +111 ypg in their L/4 while Rice is -18. Bulls have a chance to match LY's win total here. Rice has been tough at home (+110 ypg) so we won't run wild but we do like USF by 2 td's.

TEXAS TECH by 6 over West Virginia - WVU snapped a 4 game SU/ATŚ losing streak to TT last season, pulling the outright upset 20-13 (+6) at home. WVU got their 6th win of the season last week as they ran for 200 yds (3.7) and jumped out to a 28-7 lead and upset UCF 31-21. TT put up 543 yds in a 56-48 win at Okla St last week with QB Morton throwing for 366 (70%, 4-1 ratio). WVU has the #121 pass D (63%, 22-4) and QB Morton hits 63% with a 25-7 ratio and TT's top 3 WR's all have 550+ yards. WVU does well stopping the run (135, 3.9) but will face RB Brooks (1317, 5.0, 14 td). WVU has faced the tougher schedule (#8 vs #46) and TT allows 454 ypg in B12 play, but TT is a slight favorite here & at home we like them to get the win & cover.

Jacksonville St by 3 over WKU - Jax St has clinched a spot in the CUSA Title game while WKU needs to win and have Liberty lose. LY WKU led 17-7 2Q. It was 17-10 4Q when Jax St went 91/11 td & 45/10, kicking the GW fg as time expired. Jax St has won 8 straight (6-2 ATS) including LW against Sam Houston 21-11. WKU was 7-2 until they lost to LA Tech at home then last week they allowed 419 rush yds (6.7) at Liberty and lost 38-21 (+3). TROY by 21 over Southern Miss - Since 2021 Troy has won & covered the L/3 meetings, winning by 16 ppg. After starting 1-7 SU, Troy has won 2 of their L/3 games. The Trojans have gone to QB Caldwell and over his past 4 starts has thrown for 991 yds (67%) with a 10-5 ratio and RB's Green and Taylor have each topped 100 yds in at least 1 game over the L/4. Troy has also allowed just 326 ypg over the past 3 games. SMiss is 1-10 on the season and have yet to best an FBS foe. They are -197 ypg/-24 ypg in SBC play and average just 270 ypg/14ppg. Their defense is allowing 233 (6.0) rush in SBC play and Troy is avg'g 198 rush ypg (4.5) over the L/4 games. While it may seem tough to lay over 2 td's with a 3-win team, SMiss has thrown in the towel, while Troy looks to end the ssn on a high note & build toward the future.

Fau by 3 over TULSA - FAU is 2-1 SU/ATS in this series since '14. LY the Owls ran for 234 yds and won 20-17 (-3). FAU played their first game under Interim HC Chad Lunsford last week and lost to Charlotte who was also playing under a new Interim HC. FAU trailed 16-10 at half but briefly led in the 4Q 27-26 before allowing a 47 yd td pass then a 22 yd fumble return td and lost by 12. Tulsa is 3-8 and just fired HC Kevin Wilson. Their Interim HC is 30 YO Ryan Switzer. The Golden Hurricane are -167 in AAC play while FAU is -100. Owls have yet to win an AAC game while Tulsa's only win was a ridiculous comeback from down 42-17 3Q vs UTSA. Tulsa took over the bottom spot in our Pass D rankings. They've given up an FBS high 318 pass ypg and 33 pass td's allowed. FAU was at least competitve last week so we give them a 3 pt edge.

Kansas by 3 over BAYLOR - Two of the hottest teams in the B12 square off. Baylor has won 5 straight (4-0-1 ATS) and are avg'g 486 ypg/41 ppg during that 5 game win streak. Kansas has pulled off 3 straight outright upsets against 3 teams battling for a berth in the B12 title game (lowa St, BYU, Colo). KU is rushing for 208 ypg (4.7) over their L/4 games incl an incredible 331 (5.8) last week where RB Neal ran for 207 (5.6) and QB Daniels ran for 72 yards (12.0 ypc). Baylor allows 151 rush (4.0) in B12 play, but allowed 262 (5.3) to WVU and 265 (5.9) to ISU. KU did hold Colo to their 2nd lowest yardage total last week (308) and their pass D has allowed 21 td's but has 14 int's. Baylor already has a bowl locked up while KU needs one more win for #6 and we like them to continue their winning ways in what should be a close, high-scoring game.

Texas by 6 over TEXAS A&M - Huge implications in this renewed rivalry with the winner heading to the SEC Title game. They last met as Big 12 foes in 2011. Texas has had a very favorable SEC schedule, only playing one of the current ranked teams but lost 30-15 at home vs Georgia and they were outgained 170-38 in the 1H. A&M lost to Notre Dame at home in the opener but they've their next 5 home games including over LSU by 15 and Mizzou by 31. The Aggies are +128 ypg at home but Texas is +120 on the road including a 19 pt win The Big House. Texas is the more talented team and we love their defense that is holding foes to 247 ypg and 136 ypg below their avg but A&M has a solid defense and is angry off a loss to Auburn where they trailed 21-0 but fought back and lost in 4OT. This is a game we will just enjoy watching so we are nutting it right at the line.

Louisville by 6 over KENTÜCKY - KY is 5-0 SU/ATS in this series including LY's 38-31 win over #9 Louisville where the Cardinals had a 403-289 yd edge. UL led by 10 points twice but KY got a 100 yd KR td and 3 TO's. UL is off an impressive 37-9 win over Pitt wher they held a 505-265 yd edge. That same Pitt team nearly beat Clemson the week prior. KY is 4-7 and first time staying home for bowl season since Stoops 3rd year (2015). 'Cats were held to 14 pts and 232 yds as we cashed a 3★ LP Totals play on the Under in their 31-14 (+20') loss at Texas LW. KY's only P4 win this year came over Ole Miss and since then they are 0-5 SU/2-3 ATS and all 5 losses were by 7 or more. UL has wins over 5 bowl eligible teams including #12 Clemson and 3 of their 4 losses came to teams currently projected to make the CFB Playoff. UL is +90 ypg while KY is -2 against similar sked strength and we will call for the Cardinals to get revenge and beat their rival for the first time in 6 tries.

MISSOURI by 1 over Arkansas - These two play for the Battle Line Rivalry. Mizzou is 7-1 SU/4-4 ATS and the home team is 7-3 SU/ATS in the series. Ark won their 6th game to get bowl eligible LW, beating LA Tech 35-14 (-25). The Hogs never led by more than 21 but did finish w/a 454-229 yd edge. Mizzou led Miss St 31-20 4Q and added a td with 5:40 left. They finished w/a 472-338 yd edge. Hogs are +91 ypg but -16 vs the SEC. Mizzou is +79 ypg but -35 vs the SEC and Ark ply'd a much tougher sked (#31 vs #60). Hogs have edges on offense and ST's but Mizzou has the better D. There is some concern that Ark is flat after getting their 6th win and Mizzou is 27-6 SU at home under Drinknwitz while Ark is 6-14 SU on the road and the line is just above a fg so we are playing it safe and calling for Mizzou to pull out a close win.

Some thought Bama's loss to OK last week eliminated the Tide from the playoffs but the latest CFP Poll has the Tide #13, sitting just outside the projected field. Aub needs a win to get bowl elig and is coming off a wild 4 OT win over A& where they blew a 21-0 lead.QB Peyton Thorne has a 20-8 ratio and Aub's Jarquez Hunter has 1,145 (6.6). Jalen Milroe is coming off his worst game (3 int's) and faces an Auburn D that holds foes 67 ypg below their avg and allows just 55% completions. Bama is +12 ypg vs the SEC but Aub is +79! We think Bama wins but Hugh Freeze is 19-9 ATS as road dog and Auburn will put up a strong fight. IOWA ST by 7 over Kansas St - 108th meeting of Farmageddon! lowa St has won 4 of the L/6 meetings & have covered 4 in a row. Last season ISU (+10) pulled the outright upset 42-35 as RB Sama ran for 276 yds (17.3 ypc!!). ISU needs to win here to reach the Big 12 title game and they have won 2 straight after losing 2 in a row to Tex Tech and Kansas. KSt bounced back with a 41-15 win over Cincy, as they ran for 281 yds (7.0) led by RB Giddens (143, 9.5) and QB Johnson threw for 2 td's after having a 1-4 ratio the prior 2 games. ISU does hold foes to 67 ypg under their avg (#19) and are +90 ypg in B12 play and +131 ypg at home. ISU also has the #6 pass D (53%, 9-14). ISU does have RB's Sama & Hansen, plus QB Becht is hitting 62% with a 18-8 ratio. At night in front of their home crowd we like the more consistent ISU squad to get the win

While Oregon is playing with revenge after losing twice to UW last season, UO is playing with unbeaten pressure and have a bigger game on deck. In their last game UO only beat Wisky 16-13 on the road and in their last home game led Maryland by only 11 in the 4Q before adding 2 late scores. With the line close to 3 td's, we lean with the Huskies here.

INDIANA by 35 Purdue - Indiana has lost 5 of the L/6 meetings both SU/ATS. However this is a new era for Indiana football and they are off a loss to Ohio St where they were let down by their punting unit and the offense only put up 151 yards and 70 of those were on their opening drive. However this rivalry game is one IU HC Cignetti metioned when he first got the job and have a chance to pour it on a Purdue team that is allowing foes to gain 92 ypg above their avg (#128) and their pass D ranks #127 (65%, 21-4) and QB Rourke is hitting 70% with a 21-4 ratio. After playing Mich & OSU's defense, Cignetti will want his offense to gain confidence & IU's defense is holding foes 84 ypg under their avg (#12) and held OSU to 316 yds last week. Even with the line above 4 td's we lean with the Hoosiers. PENN ST by 28 over Maryland - Since 16 PSU is 7-1 SU/ATS vs Maryland with their only loss coming in the '20 Covid season. In those 7 wins PSU has beaten Maryland by and avg of 38 ppg and their smallest win is by 17 pts. PSU does hold foes to 97 ypg under their season avg (#7) and have the #17 pass D. Maryland QB Edwards was banged up last week so it could be MJ Morris at QB. Maryland is -45 ypg on the road and their defense is allowing foes to gain 18 ypg above their avg and PSU has the stellar run game (192, 5.2) plus TE Warren (910, 12.1) is a matchup nightmare. Penn St is 8-3 ATS the L/2 ssn's as a favorite of 20+ points and we like them here by 4 td's. NEW MEXICO ST by 7 over Utep - NMSt has won 4 out of the L/6 (5-1 ATS) in the Battle of I-10. UTEP is 0-6 SU/2-4 ATS and -133 ypg on the road. Two of NMSt's 3 wins have come at home including an upset over LA Tech. LW the Aggies picked up their first road win, beating Middle Tenn 36-21. Surprisingly UTEP is -31 ypg vs the CUSA. NMSt is -116 ypg vs CUSA but only -67 at home. Aggies are rushing for 177 ypg (4.4) and QB Parker Awad just had his best game. UTEP is allowing 178 rush ypg (4.4) but they didn't play CUSA's top rush offense (Jax St). Aggies have shown us more whe

WSU is led by QB Mateer who hits 64% and has a 28-6 ratio, plus is also their top rusher (770, 4.8). WSU does struggle on defense and just allowed 534 to New Mexico and 484 to Oregon St the L/2 gms. Wyo did actually beat NMex earlier this season & put up a ssn-high 604 yds. Wyo has gone to QB Anderson (58%, 6-3 ratio) and RB Waylee has 254 (5.0) in his 3 starts. The line currently sits at over 2 td's, but given WSU's recent struggles on defense, we think Wyo will keep this game within the line.

Notre Dame by 3 over USC - Home team is 8-2 SU/9-1 ATS in this series. We cashed both a 4 **

ND is +147 ypg but they've only taken on our #51 sked. USC clinched a bowl last week by beating rival UCLA 19-13 (-5) and the Trojans are +64 ypg against our #7 sked. The Trojans are +114 ypg at home and theyare +7' but haven't lost a game by more than a td all season. USC avg 29 ppg and 430 ypg but 37 ppg/461 ypg at home and they nearly upset Penn St in LA, losing 33-30 in OT. This is ND's first true road game since Sept 14th at Purdue. USC will be fired up to try to knock their rival out of a playoff spot. The series has been dominated by the home team but there hasn't been an upset since 2011 so we like USC to keep it close but ND gets the win.

UNLV by 17 over Nevada - Battle for the Fremont Cannon. The home team is just 4-7 SU/3-8 ATS in the L/11 meetings. UNLV needs a win to secure their spot in the MW title game and were +226 yards in their last game and have won 3 straight since their loss to Boise. Nev is a scrappy team and 3 of their last 5 losses are by 7 pts or less incl a 7 pt loss to Boise and a 3 pt loss to Fresno. Nev QB Lewis is hitting 67% with a 12-5 ratio. The one major concern for Nev is their run defense, as they have allowed 251 (5.3) the L/4 games including 318 (4.7) to Air Force last week. The line is over 2 td's and that is where we see this game ending.

New Mexico by 3 over HAWAII - After starting 0-4 NMex has won 5 of their L/6 games and need a win here for a bowl. The Lobos are avg'g 496 ypg/33 ppg in MW play and their rushing attack is putting up 255 ypg (7.0) in MW play led by QB Dampier (1051, 7.6) and RB Sanders (943, 7.3). Hawaii has allowed 290 rush (6.0) and 321 rush (7.6) the last 2 games, which does not fair well against this Lobos offense. Hawaii however does play better at home as they are +15 ypg/+8 ppg at home and -65 ypg/-19 ppg on the road. NMex's defense alo struggles, as they allow foes to gain 115 ypg above their season avg (#132) but UH QB Schager is ? with a leg inj. They played Boise close at home as well as UNLV. We see it as tough to go against either team in this situation and will call for this game to finish around the line.
