### AAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - MICHIE STADIUM - WEST POINT, NY

**3★ Tulane over ARMY (Friday)** - Tulane has won the last 4 in this series '15, '17, '19 & '20. This is Tulane's 3rd straight trip to the AAC Title game. They beat UCF in '22 but lost LY to SMU. The Green Wave had already clinched a spot in this game going into their Thanksgiving night affair with Memphis. They were -14 but lost 34-24 and were -3 TO's. We cashed our **5★ GOY** on Tulane -7 when they dominated Navy 35-0 and had a 358-113 yd edge. HC Jon Sumrall faced Army twice as HC at Troy, winning 19-0 with a 449-255 yd edge last year and 10-9 in '22. Army trailed UTSA 17-13 3Q last week. They were ahead 29-17 4Q, allows UTSA to go 75/4 td then missed a fg and int'd UTSA on their last possession. Tulane is +125 ypg against our #70 sked. Army is +106 ypg but they've faced the weakest sked (#134) in the FBS. Tulane has spent every monday working on defending the triple option and they've obviously been successful. They are 4-1-1 ATS on the road with wins at Louisiana and at Navy. They also were competitive against two P4 teams, Kansas St (lost by 7) and Oklahoma while Army faced one P4 and were crushed by Notre Dame 49-14. Tulane's D will shut down the option once again so we are going with the Green Wave by two scores.

### SEC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - MERCEDEZ-BENZ STADIUM - ATLANTA, GA

**2★ † Georgia over Texas** - Georgia has played at least one game in Mercedes Benz Stadium each year since '17 and already beat Clemson here 34-3 in the opener. This is a rematch of this year's previous meeting won by Georgia 30-15 in Austin. The Dawgs led that game 23-0 w/a 170-38 yd edge at half. Texas has won all 5 games since including last week at Texas A&M 17-7 and they finished w/a 458-248 yd edge. RB Quintrevion Wisner ran for a career high 186 yards. Georgia was in a huge flat spot last week, laying 18 points against a feisty Georgia Tech squad known for pulling upsets and the Dawgs had already clinched their trip to the SEC Title game. We went against Georgia and cashed a **3★ LPS** on the Jackets in a wild 44-42 win. Georgia was outgained 563-405. Texas is +203 ypg and +154 w/a the SEC while Georgia is +93 and +56 w/a the SEC but Georgia played the tougher sked (#7 vs #34) and Texas' lopsided 32 point win came against a Florida team that was starting a w/o 3rd string QB and missing their top WR, top RB and top 3 DB's. When Georgia has put full attention on a team they've been dominant with wins over Texas and Tennessee. Georgia already beat Texas in Austin yet they are the underdog. We picked Georgia to win the first meeting and we are doing so again here for a **2★** selection!

### FRIDAY DECEMBER 6TH

#### CONFERENCE USA CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - AMFIRST STADIUM - JACKSONVILLE, AL

**JACKSONVILLE ST by 10 over Wku** - Jax St gets to host their first ever CUSA Title game. WKU is making their first trip to the CUSA Title game since '21 and 4th overall. The 'Toppers won it back in '15 and '16. This is a rematch of last week's game which WKU won 19-17. That game was meaningless for Jax St yet WKU needed a GW 50 yard fg with :03 left to win and earn their spot here. The 'Toppers did finish w/a 426-328 yd edge but Jax St lost QB Tyler Huff to injury in the 3rd quarter. The Gamecocks have an experienced backup in Logan Smothers who started 4 games last year. Huff has thrown for 2,003 yards and only 11 pass td's but just 6 int's and he has rushed for 1,176 (6.1) and 13 td's. RB Tre Stewart has rushed for 1,400 (5.9). Jax St is +88 vs the CUSA while WKU is +22. Last week's game was on the road and JSU is only 3-3 SU/2-4 ATS and -19 ypg on the road but they have won 5 straight home games (4-1 ATS, +148 ypg) and this game is being played in Jacksonville. WKU is 3-3 SU/ATS on the road including a 17 point loss to Liberty two weeks ago where they allowed 419 rush. Don't read too much into last week's game as WKU had a clear motivation edge. The Gamecocks have been the better team all season and they should be in good shape regardless who plays QB so we like Jax St to win their first CUSA Title.

#### MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - ALBERTSONS STADIUM - BOISE, ID

**BOISE ST by 7 over Unlv** - Rematch of the MW title game from last season where Boise (-2) went up 31-17 HT (323-203) and won 44-20 with a 527-298 yd edge and RB Jeanty ran for 153 (7.3). These teams met in the regular season at UNLV and the Rebels went up 10-3 late 1Q but Boise outscored them 17-0 2Q and led 20-10 HT. UNLV took a 24-23 lead into the 4Q but Boise scored early 4Q to go up 29-24. Boise stopped UNLV then ran out the final 8:07 to leave Vegas with a win. UNLV was only 1 of 3 teams to hold Boise to under 200 rush yds and they will have the task again of slowing down Heisman hopeful Jeanty (2288, 7.3, 28 td). Boise QB Madsen is quietly having a good season, hitting 62% with a 21-3 ratio. UNLV does have the #25 pass D (57%, 19-17) and are holding foes to 40 ypg under their avg. UNLV's "go-go" offense avg'd 434 ypg overall incl 254 rush ypg (5.6). Over the L4 UNLV avg'd 275 rush ypg (5.7) incl 351 (8.4) in their final game vs Nev. However Boise allowed just 97 rush ypg (3.2) in MW play and they have 44 sks on the season incl 6 vs UNLV earlier this ssn. Against 6 common foes Boise is +120 ypg/+22 ppg and UNLV is +117 ypg/+14 ppg. Boise is +158 ypg/+25 ppg at home and they will have the altitude edge plus the weather will be in the 30's with possible snow. Boise has been playing close games of late trying to survive but now they are 1 game away from a CFP birth. This is the 8th MW title game for Boise and at home where they are used to playing in the colder temps, so we'll lean with Boise here.

### SATURDAY DECEMBER 7TH

#### BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - AT&T STADIUM - ARLINGTON, TX

**† Iowa St by 3 over Arizona St** - First meeting. ASU was picked near the bottom of the Big 12 this season, but enter this game with a 10-2 SU/ATS record with both of their losses coming on the road to TTech by 8 and Cincy by 10. Since the Cincy loss ASU won and covered their L5 games as they were +108 ypg/+16 ppg over that stretch. ISU started the season winning their F/7 games before getting upset by TTech at home & then at Kansas allowed 532 yds in a 45-36 loss. ISU bounced back to win their L3 games. ASU is propelled by RB Skattebo, who still ran for 1,398 yds (5.7) despite missing a game. ISU's defense held foes to 65 ypg under their avg (#18) but did struggle at times vs the run, allowing 354 (9.1) to UCF and 287 (7.4) to Kansas. ISU does have the #5 pass D (52%, 12-14). ASU's defense was also strong this season, holding foes to 73 ypg under their avg (#16). ISU is solid on offense and QB Becht has thrown for 3,021 yds (20-8 ratio) and WR's Higgins and Noel both have topped 1,000 yards on the season. ASU counters with the #15 pass D (58%, 14-14) and they allow just 117 rush ypg (3.8) but ISU does have 3 talented RB's in Hansen, Sama and Jackson. ASU's leading WR Tyson (1101, 14.7, 10 td) will be out for this game and their #2 receiver is RB Skattebo. Against 6 common B12 foes ISU was +47 ypg while ASU was -17 ypg. Campbell is the more exp'd HC and this is the best team he has fielded here, so we like ISU to pay that off with a B12 title game win & they are a slight dog.

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### MAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - FORD FIELD - DETROIT, MI

**† Ohio by 1 over Miami, Oh** - Battle of the Bricks for the MAC title. Ohio has been to the MAC title game 5 times prior, but have not won any of them. They last were here in 2022 and lost to Toledo 17-7 with a backup QB. Miami is the defending MAC champ and they make their 7th appearance in this game (4-2 record). Miami was just 1-3 in non-conf play, but played N'Western and Cincy tough but only beat UMass by 3 pts. After a 10-pt loss to Toledo in the MAC opener, Miami won their final 7 games (6-1 ATS) with the only non-cover coming vs Kent (-30', won 34-7). Ohio was 2-2 in non-conf play (lost at 'Cuse, at UK) then opened MAC play 2-0. Ohio did lose to Miami 30-20 (trailed 16-0 HT) but after that loss, would win and cover their final 5 games. They won by an avg of 27 ppg and were +164 ypg during that win streak & their defense allowed just 270 ypg over the final 5 gms. Miami's defense was also great in MAC play, allowing just 275 ypg and over the L4 gms allowed 253 ypg/12 ppg. Ohio's strength is their run game (225, 5.4 in MAC play) led by RB Tyus (960, 5.2) and QB Navarro (869, 6.6). Miami only allowed 93 rush ypg (2.7) in MAC play incl 110 (3.3) to Ohio this ssn. Miami QB Gabbert was great in MAC play, throwing for 218 ypg and had an 18-4 ratio. Both teams can get after the QB as Ohio had 15 sks their L4 games while Miami also had 15. This is a tough game for us to call, but we will call for the slight dog to get the outright win.

### SUN BELT CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - CAJUN FIELD - LAFAYETTE, LA

**LOUISIANA by 10 over Marshall** - LA has made the SBC title game 5 times but only have won it once (2021) and in '20 the game was not played. This is Marshall's first trip to the SBC title game, but made the CUSA title game 3 times. The Cajuns were strong in year 3 under HC Desormeaux as they posted a 10-2 record, with both losses coming by 8 pts or less. Marshall went 2-2 in non-conf play, but the losses were to Ohio St and VA Tech. Their only SBC loss shouldn't have even happened as they were up 23-3 entering the 4Q but allowed 21 pts the final 7 min and lost to GSthrn 24-23. Marshall has struggled at times defending the run, as they allowed 200+ rush yds 4 times in SBC play including 286 (6.2) at ODU and 244 (4.9) at JMU. The Cajuns do run the ball well (181, 5.1) incl 223 (5.1) last week and are led by RB's Davis (662, 5.0) and Perry (621, 6.5). The Cajuns are allowing 145 (4.5) rush but face a Marshall offense that avg'd 204 rush (5.1) in SBC play and are led by RB Turner (864, 8.3) and QB Braxton (544, 4.6) who also has a 17-2 ratio on the season. LA lost QB Wooldrige for the season just a few weeks ago, but backup QB Fields has experience & since taking over he has thrown for 626 yds (73%, 5-1 ratio). LA is +90 ypg/+15 ppg at home while MU is -37 ypg/-2 ppg on the road & in SBC play LA is +88 ypg while MU is -16 ypg. The Cajuns have a great home field edge and we feel they are the more impressive team & will get the win by 2 scores.

### ACC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BANK OF AMERICA STADIUM - CHARLOTTE, NC

**† Clemson by 7 over Smu** - First meeting comes in the ACC Title game. SMU gave up more than \$200 million in media rights revenue for it's first 9 years of membership but the move has turned out to be brilliant as the Mustangs are back in a Power conference for the first time in 40 years and are playing for the ACC Title in their first year. Clemson is 8-1 SU/7-2 ATS in ACC Title games and they've actually won their last 8 by an avg 26 pt MOV. SMU did win the AAC Title just last year, beating Tulane 26-14 (+3). Clemson comes in 9-3 but only have 1 ACC loss to Louisville where they had a 450-366 yd edge and were +12 FD's. SMU is 11-1 and they've won all 8 ACC games but did benefit from a light ACC sked where they missed #2, #3, #4 and #6 in the conference standings. SMU had close wins at Louisville and Duke but they've won their last 4 by 22 ppg (+114 ypg) including last week when they crushed a banged up Cal squad 38-6 with a 415-254 yd edge. We think there is value on Clemson coming off their loss to South Carolina which they led late. These two have played 5 common foes (FSU, UL, Stan, Pitt & UVA) and Clemson is 4-1 SU/1-4 ATS, +10.2 ppg & +96 ypg while SMU is 5-0 SU/ATS, +22.6 ppg & +153 ypg. Clearly those numbers favor SMU but we like Clemson's experience in this game and they should have a decent crowd edge so we are taking the Tigers to win by a touchdown.

### BIG 10 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LUCAS OIL STADIUM - INDIANAPOLIS, IN

**† Oregon by 1 over Penn St** - These two last met in the 1995 Rose Bowl won by Penn St 38-20. Oregon made the Big 10 Title game in their first year in the conference. Penn St's only other trip to the Big 10 Title game was in '16 when they beat Wisconsin 38-31. Oregon did reach the Pac-12 Title game six times, going 4-2 but lost their last two in '21 and '23. The Ducks are the only unbeaten FBS team remaining. Last week Oregon was -18 at home vs Washington. They only led 7-6 2Q then scored 3 td's in a span of 3:12 to pull away and won 49-21. The Ducks are +165 ypg on the entire season and +165 vs the Big-10. Three of Oregon's wins came by 3 points or less but they also won 8 games by 21 points or more. Penn St is 11-1 and won 4 straight. Last week Penn St was -25 at home vs Maryland. The Nittany Lions took no mercy on the 'Terps, leading 38-7 they scored a 15 yd td pass on the game's final play for a 44-7 final. Penn St is +176 on the ssn and +132 vs the Big 10. These two played 7 common foes. Oregon went 7-0 SU/4-3 ATS, +19.7 ppg & +150 ypg. Penn St is 6-1 SU/4-3 ATS, +21.9 ppg & +143 ypg. Penn St has a slight edge on D, holding foes to 267 ypg and they hold foes 100 ypg below their avg. Oregon's D is nearly as good, allowing 284 ypg and they hold foes 84 ypg below their avg. Oregon has a slight edge on offense but the big difference is ST's with Oregon #14 vs #102. The Ducks are laying just over a fg at presstime and we think everything about this game feels like it comes down to the wire. Oregon squeaks out another close win but Penn St covers.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ MINNESOTA over Atlanta** - MIN is back at home after a comeback win vs ARZ where they trailed 19-6 late 3Q but from that point outscored ARZ 17-3 and scored the GW td with 1:17 left 4Q. ATL did lose at home 17-13 vs LAC despite allowing just 187 yds as QB Cousins threw 4 int's. ATL's pass D could be in for a long day here as they are allowing 72% completions on the season (222 ypg) and MIN has WR's Jefferson and Addison plus TE Hockenson. ATL's rush attack avg's just 118 (4.3) and MIN does have a strong run D, allowing just 81 ypg (3.7) and they have 39 sacks on the season. ATL QB Cousins makes his return to MIN but he has a 17-13 ratio and will be under constant pressure and with ATL facing a tough MIN run D, MIN will blitz Cousins often. ATL is on a 3-game SU/ATS losing streak and an aging QB Cousins will struggle plus the Falcons cannot rely on their ST's as K Koo is 6-12 on FG's in ATL's last six games.

**FORECAST: Minnesota by 20**

**3★ Buffalo over LA RAMS** - The Bills enter here winners of 7 in a row (6-1 ATS) as they just beat up on a banged up 49ers team 35-10 in the snow where they held a 372-239 yd edge and were +3 TO's. The Rams grabbed an unimpressive 21-14 win over NOLA last week where they were actually outgained 327-322. BUF QB Allen can do it with his arm (65%, 20-5 ratio) and with his legs (334, 4.8, 6 td) and RB Cook is a capable runner. BUF also has a great group of receivers and over the L/4 games th Rams have allowed 70% completions and their pass rush has just 7 sacks in the L/4 games incl no sacks a week ago. BUF's OL has allowed just 13 sacks all season incl just 3 sacks the L/4 games! BUF is allowing just 307 ypg during their win streak and are allowing just 183 pass ypg the past 4 games. BUF will also likely have a large number of fans from "Bills Mafia" on hand so there is no real home edge for the Rams here and we like the Bills to keep rolling.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ ARIZONA over Seattle** - These NFC West foes do battle for the 2nd time in 3 weeks. In their earlier meeting in SEA, it was a cold/rainy afternoon and the game changed on a pick-six thrown by ARZ QB Murray. This game will be inside, so weather will not be a factor here and the Cardinals have covered their L/5 games where the weather was not a factor. ARZ has a dynmaic offense led by Murray, RB Conner, WR Harrison and TE McBride. ARZ's defense though has stepped up during this recent surge, allowing just 252 ypg/14 ppg over their L/4 games and they have 19 sacks in those 4 games incl getting 5 vs SEA in their last meeting. While the defense for SEA has been good the L/3 games (278 ypg, 15 ppg) the offense is only avg'g 278 ypg in those 3 games. With Murray being able to make plays with both his legs and feet indoors, we feel like that gives ARZ an advantage and SEA is playing their 3rd road game in 4 weeks. We like the Cardinals to grab the win in a division revenge game.

## OTHER PLAYS

**Green Bay vs DETROIT - Thursday** - Both teams are off wins on Thanksgiving as DET won 23-20 over CHI where they led 16-0 HT and led 23-7 going into the 4Q. CHI scored the game's final 10 pts and DET had to hold them off at the end. GB had their way with MIA as they led 24-3 HT and went on to win 30-17. In their earlier meeting DET won at Lambeau 24-14 despite GB having a 411-261 yd edge (DET pick-six). GB's pass D could get back CB Alexander but they have allowed 74% and 221 ypg over the L/4 games. DET QB Goff is hitting 72% with a 22-9 ratio and their 1-2 punch at RB of Gibbs/Montgomery is the best in the NFL. GB does allow only 107 rush ypg (4.2) & over the L/4 gms have allowed just 97 ypg (3.7). DET's run D is allowing just 94 ypg (4.4) and did record 5 sks, but lost another DEF starter for the season to injury and their pass D has been suspect at times. **Call the office on Thur after Noon EST for the Marquee Winner!**

**New Orleans by 3 over NY GIANTS** - Saints travel up north to take on a Giants team sputtering, as they have lost 7 in a row and lost 27-20 at DAL on Thanksgiving. The Saints have dealt with several inj's and last week lost jack-of-all-trades player Taysom Hill and they are missing several OL starters. NOLA still has RB Kamara and they have put up 398 ypg over the L/4 games and the Giants pass D allows 70% completions on the season, plus they allow 154 rush ypg (4.6) over the L/4 games. NYG's offense has put up just 290 ypg over the L/4 games and their OL has allowed 10 sks the L/2 games since the QB change. The Giants did show some fight last week in DAL, and here at home in December vs a dome team we feel like the Giants can keep this game close and the line is over a fg. **TENNESSEE by 1 over Jacksonville** - After TEN went 10-4 SU/ATS from 2017-2021, JAX has won 3 of the past 4 meetings. These teams have a combined 5 wins and JAX lost QB Lawrence after a big hit last week and it will likely be Mac Jones here. TEN beat Houston 2 weeks ago but followed that up with a 42-19 loss at Wash where they allowed 463 yards. Up until last week TEN had not allowed 400 yds in a game and that was a good offense, here they face a JAX team with a backup QB, and inj's to several of their top skill players. JAX is avg'g just 225 ypg over their L/4 games. TEN's offense isn't anything great (297 ypg, 18 ppg) but should be able to move the ball some on a JAX defense allowing foes to gain 74 ypg above their season avg (#32 NFL). JAX is 2-10 SU on the season but TEN is 2-9-1 ATS so we will call for TEN to win but JAX to cover.

**TAMPA BAY by 4 over Las Vegas** - Vegas put up a fight against the Chiefs last Friday in Arrowhead as they lost 19-17 and could have had a shot to win if not for a bad snap late. LV QB O'Connell threw for 340 yards and 2 td's last week and now faces a TB pass D allowing 67% completions and 258 pass ypg. TB has put up 450 and 445 yds in the L/2 games since their bye week and last week TB ran for 236 (6.1) led by RB Irving (152, 6.1). TB QB Mayfield is hitting 71% with a 25-11 ratio and faces a Raiders pass D allowing 65% completions and 261 pass ypg the L/4 games. LV did have 5 sacks last week against KC and Mayfield could have limited mobility after getting cleared last week. TB is favored by a td but needed OT to get past CAR last week and LV's pass attack will keep them in this game.

**PITTSBURGH by 11 over Cleveland** - These AFC North foes just met a little over two weeks ago in CLE where they played in a snowstorm with CLE grabbing a 24-19 win despite PIT having the yards edge (368-304) and being +2 in TO's. CLE is off short rest after playing this past MON in DEN and QB Winston threw for 497 yds and 4 TD's but also threw 3 int's incl 2 pick sixes and CLE lost 41-32. PIT was also apart of a high-scoring game in Cincy, beating the Bengals 44-38 as QB Wilson threw for 414 yds and 3 td's and five players from PIT had at least 3 catches. PIT is +15 TO's this ssn and they are facing a QB who is TO prone. CLE struggles to run and PIT only allows 91 rush ypg (4.1). PIT is also allowing opposing QB's to hit just 59% over the L/4 gms. PIT's only loss & non-cover over their L/7 is vs CLE so they will be out for revenge & since 2021 the home team is 6-1 SU/ATS in this series.

**PHILADELPHIA by 17 over Carolina** - The Eagles continued their hot streak last week in Baltimore, getting the outright upset 24-19 despite getting outgained 372-252 as BAL missed 2 fg's and were stopped on downs once. RB Barkley again topped 100 yds for the 6th time in the L/7 gms and for the season has 1,499 yds (6.1) and here takes on a CAR run defense allowing 167 ypg (4.8) and last week to Tampa they gave up 236 rush yds (6.1). CAR's pass D also struggles, allowing 71% completions and 242 ypg pass ypg on the road. Philly's defense has been rock solid during their 8 game win streak, allowing just 241 ypg/15 ppg and last week vs BAL allowed over 100 rush yds for the first time since Week 4! Philly also gets after the passer (36 sks). CAR's defense is allowing foes to gain 61 ypg above their avg (#31) and on offense are gaining 58 ypg under what their foes allow, which is last in the NFL. This line is almost at 2 td's, but it is impossible to not lean with Philly right now.

**MIAMI by 10 over Ny Jets** - The Jets fell to 3-9 after last week's debacle where they were up 21-7 about to go up 3 scores and then QB Rodgers threw a pick-six and SEA wound up coming back to win 26-21. Miami is back home in sunny Florida after playing in frigid Green Bay at night on Thanksgiving, where they fell behind 24-3 and wound up losing 30-17. Almost all of MIA's yds the last few weeks have come through the air as they threw for 271, 308 and 336 their L/3 games but ran for just 82, 65 and 39 yards. NYJ could be w/o CB Gardner too, which would be trouble vs a great MIA pass attack. The Jets only avg 253 ypg over their L/4 games incl just 90 rush ypg (4.5) and MIA is allowing just 291 ypg at home and their run D has only allowed 83 ypg (4.1) over the L/4 games. This Jets season is lost, while MIA still has a shot to make a wildcard push, so we'll back the Dolphins at home.

**Chicago by 3 over SAN FRANCISCO** - Both teams come into this game on multi-game losing streaks as SF has now dropped 3 in a row while CHI is up to 6 losses in a row and after their Thanksgiving debacle, fired their HC. SF the last 3 games has put up just 252 ypg/12 ppg and will be w/o RB's Mason and McCaffrey and QB Purdy is less than 100% as well. CHI's last 3 losses are by 3 pts or less and showed fight in DET last Thur after falling behind 16-0 and 23-7. In the 2 games since CHI fired their OC, rookie QB Williams has thrown for 340 and 256 yds with a combined 5-0 ratio. CHI has struggled at times to run the ball (109, 4.1) but the 49ers allowed 169 (4.0) and 220 (5.8) the L/2 games. Teams often play their best football the game after firing their HC (Saints did it earlier this season) and with SF dealing with a ton of inj's we like the Bears to break through & pull the upset.

**La Chargers vs KANSAS CITY - SNF** - Since 2019 KC is 9-2 SU vs LAC but just 5-6 ATS and LAC has actually covered 6 of the L/9 games. In their earlier meeting this season LAC jumped out to a 10-0 lead 1Q and KC needed a late 4Q td to go up 17-10 (KC was -7). KC is off another close call where they benefitted from a bad snap by Vegas in a 19-17 win while LAC won 17-13 despite putting up just 187 yds vs ATL (picked off ATL QB Cousins 4 times). Chargers have won and covered 5 of their L/6 games while KC has failed to cover their L/6 games and are just 2-4 ATS as a home favorite this season. QB Mahomes has thrown 11 int's this season and outside of TE Kelce, does not have another consistent target he can rely on. They have also allowed 32 sks this season incl 10 the L/2 gms. LAC has 36 sacks on the season but their OL has also allowed 35 sks and face a KC defense holding teams to 34 ypg under their season avg (#3) and allow just 88 rush ypg (3.7).

**Cincinnati vs DALLAS - MNF** - This matchup has lost a lot of shine since the beginning of the season. DAL has won their L/2 games while Cincy has now dropped 3 straight and at 4-8 are likely out of the playoff picture after a 44-38 loss to PIT. DAL's offense is only avg'g 296 ypg/19 ppg the L/4 games but take on a Cincy defense that has allowed 435 yards/34 points and 510 yards/44 points in their L/2 games. It feels like a wasted year for QB Burrow as he is #1 in the NFL in pass yards (3,337) and td passes (30) and WR Chase is #1 in the NFL in rec yards (1142, 14.5, 13 td). DAL does have their pass rush back to almost full health and have 10 sacks the L/2 games, while Cincy's OL has allowed 30 sacks and they only average 92 rush ypg (4.2).
