3rd meeting & last met in 1978. This is Penn St's first trip to the CFP and are 4-5 SU/5-4 ATS in postseason games under HC Franklin. This is the biggest game in SMU history as they are in the CFP in their first year as a P4 team. SMU is 0-2 SU/ATS in postseason games under HC Lashlee.

SMU moved to the ACC in '24 and started off the season with a close win at Nev but lost to BYU at home and were 2-1. From that point on SMU won their final 9 regular season games, with 7 of those wins coming by 10+ points. SMU did lose in the ACC title game to Clemson 34-31 on a last sec FG. QB Jennings took over as the starter vs BYU and went on to have a stellar season (3050, 66%, 22-8) with 379 rush (4.1). RB Smith was the feature RB & finished with 1267 (5.9, 14 td). On defense SMU held teams to 40 ypg under their avg (#38) and only allowed 93 rush (2.7), plus recorded 40 sacks! Their pass D ranks #30 (56%, 24-15).

Expectations were high for Penn St this season & they started off the season winning their first 7 games by an avg of 20 points. They played close with Ohio St, losing 20-13 at home, but won their L4 reg ssn games (3 wins by 4+ td's) to reach the B10 title game. In the title game both teams offenses were on full display (518-466 yd edge Penn St) but PSU was -2 TO's and they lost 45-37. Penn St finished the ssn +167 ypg/+18 ppg and their defense held foes to 91 ypg under their avg (#6). QB Allar hit 69% (2894, 21-7) and RB's Singleton & Allen were a strong 1-2 punch. TE Warren (1062, 12.1, 6 td) won the Mackey. PSU finished with 33 sks led by DE Carter (10 sks). Penn St's pass D finished #24 (59%, 15-12).

This is a noon kickoff and the temps will be in the 20's with snow/wind possible. Penn St has a strong DLine and their offense is efficient. SMU was down 24-7 vs Clemson before coming back in the ACC title gm, but in Happy Valley if they get down early it could be a long day. We like Penn St here to win & cover at home.

FORECAST: PENN ST **RATING: 4★**

These two meet for the first time. Clemson is in the playoffs for the 6th time and first time since 2020. Dabo is 7-2 ATS in playoff games and 5-2 SU/4-3 ATS as a playoff dog. Texas reached the playoffs for the first time last year but were upset by Washington 37-31 (-3). Sark is 15-10 ATS as a HF at Texas. Clemson hasn't been a double-digit dog since 2014 and Dabo is 20-12 ATS as a dog.

Clemson opened '24 with a "neutral" site loss to UGA in Atlanta by 31 pts though it was only 6-0 at half. The Tigers won their next 6 games with the closest coming at FSU when Clemson settled for 7 fg attempts. They trailed early against L'ville and lost 33-21 but did have a 450-366 yd edge. Clemson was 9-2 and led SCar late but lost by 3. In the ACC Title game they led 31-14 4Q before getting conservative on D and won on a 56 yd fg. Despite winning the ACC, Clemson was slotted behind the other conf champs and given the #12 seed and a trip to Texas. Clemson is +90 ypg and their offense puts up 71 ypg more than their foes allow. Their defense is better than their numbers suggest as they allowed garbage yards in a few lopsided wins. QB Klubnik has a 33-5 ratio.

Texas brought back 15 starters from LY's playoff team. They won their 4 non-conf games by 42 ppg including 31-12 at Mich. They opened their first ever SEC slate with 2 wins. They trailed 23-0 and held to 38 yds in the 1H of a 15 pt home loss to UGA. Texas won their last 5 SEC games to clinch a spot in the SEC Title game. In the rematch vs UGA they had a 260-54 yd edge at half but it was only 6-0. The Longhorns settled for 4 fg's and lost 22-19 in OT. Texas' D allows just 250 ypg and they are #1 in FBS, holding foes 134 ypg below their avg. Quinn Ewers has a 25-9 ratio

Texas faced one of the weaker SEC sked's with their best win at A&M. Clemson is getting DD's here and Dabo has done well as a playoff dog so we say take the points.

FORECAST: CLEMSON (+) **RATING: 2★**

These two last met in the 1995 Citrus Bowl when Tenn, led by Peyton Manning beat Eddie George and OSU 20-14. Josh Heupel is 3-2 SU/ATS in bowls. Ryan Day has OSU in the playoffs for the 6th time. Day is 2-5 ATS in Bowls and 2-2 ATS in Playoffs.

Tenn only had 9 starters back this year. QB Nico lamaleava was one of the most hyped QB's in college football. The Vols dominated their first 3 non-conf foes by 59 ppg. They won at Oklahoma then were plagued by slow starts, scoring 0 1H points in 3 straight games yet beat Florida in OT then upset Bama (both at home). They were 8-1 when they traveled to UGA and led 10-0 1Q but lost by 2 td's. The Vols were favored in their last 2 and finished 10-2, +185 ypg and +70 vs the SEC. The Vols D allows just 278 ypg and they hold foes 84 ypg below their avg (#9 in FBS). DE James Pearce and CB Jermod McCoy were both All-SEC.

OSU made a big splash in the Portal last offseason, adding QB Will Howard, RB Quinshon Judkins and Bama's Caleb Downs. The Buckeyes started 5-0, winning by 38 ppg. They were favored at Oregon but lost by 1 when Howard didn't slide in time. OSU's best win came 2 weeks later at Penn St, 20-13. They had a 316-151 yd edge vs Indiana and won 38-15. The Buckeyes were 10-1 and nearly 3 td chalk at home vs Michigan but lost 13-10, which cost them a trip to the Big 10 Title game. OSU is +182 ypg. Their offense avg 424 ypg. OSU is allowing just 241 ypg and holds foes 130 ypg below their avg (#2 in FBS). They have 5 players who were 1st Team All-Big 10.

Tenn has been plagued by slow starts. OSU has struggled to run the ball since losing 2 starting OL (130 rush ypg Lf6). Both tms have deep & physical Dlines. The checklist on the left puts this close to the line but the Under was 7-2 in OSU's Big 10 games and 5-3 in Tenn's SEC games.

Houston vs KANSAS CITY - Saturday - These teams will each play again in just 4 days on Christmas. KC got a 21-7 win in CLE last week but QB Mahomes suffered an ankle inj and is ? for this game. If he cant go it will be Carson Wentz at QB. KC did get RB Pacheco back last week but he and Karheem Hunt will split carries. HOU got a big win vs MIA last week despite putting up just 181 yds as they picked off 3 passes in a 20-12 win. HOU's offense is putting up just 281 ypg over their L/5 games but are getting help from the defense that is allowing just 302 ypg this season and have 45 sacks. KC's OL has allowed 35 sacks, but did give up 0 last week. KC also is strong on defense, allowing just 307 ypg. **Call the office on SAT after 11am EST for the Marquee Winner!**

Pittsburgh vs BALTIMORE - Saturday - Both teams are playing here on short rest and have a game on deck in just 4 days. In their earlier meeting BAL had a 329-302 yd edge and did not allow a td but 3 turnovers cost them and PIT connected on SIX fg's in an 18-16 win. PIT's offense has been shut down the past 2 games, putting up just 267 yds and 163 yds and BAL's defense has allowed just 269 ypg over their past 4 games. PIT's run D has been strong all season (94, 4.0) and allowed just 124 yds in their first meeting, but their pass D has allowed 69% and 242 ypg over the past 4 games and QB Jackson just hit 71% at home this season. BAL's pass D is allowing just 60% and 169 ypg over the L/4 games and PIT QB Wilson has thrown for just 147 and 107 the L/2 games. However PIT is 6-1 SU/ATS in games vs BAL since 2021 & the 'Under' has hit 7 straight times.

CINCINNATI by 12 over Cleveland - CLE's rough season continues as they are now 3-11 and just lost RB for the season again and after another poor performance by QB Winston (3 int's) they will turn to 2nd year QB Thomas-Robinson. Cincy kept their slim playoffs hopes alive last week with a 37-27 win where they forced 6 TO's but committed 4 TO's of their own. While Cincy's defense is allowing foes to gain 35 ypg above their season avg (#28) CLE avg's just 310 ypg and have trouble protecting the QB (58 sacks allowed) and they are -16 TO's on the season. CLE did hold Cincy to 223 yds in their last meeting, but were -2 TO's. Cincy's pass offense has played well of late, avg'g 313 ypg (68%) over the L/4 games. At home Cincy will take care of business by 2 scores.

Detroit by 7 over CHICAGO - Detroit is playing an outdoor game for just the 2nd time this season (won at GB 24-14 despite putting up just 261 yds). CHI is off short rest after playing at MIN and losing their 8th straight game, as they put up just 284 yds and 12 pts (6 pts off a late TD down 30-6). DET did lose RB Montgomery for the season along with a starting DT and CB Davis is out indef with a broken jaw. DET's defense allowed 559 yds last week. CHI's offense is only avg'g 278 ypg during their losing streak but could have some success here as long as the OL (57 sacks allowed) holds up. CHI has allowed 410 ypg/30 ppg in their L/4 games but it will remain to be seen how DET's offense operates w/o one-half of their potent 1-2 punch at RB. CHI still has weapons at WR and QB Williams has shown flashes. With some uncertainty on DET's side we will put this game right at the line.

Arizona by 7 over CAROLINA - ARZ snapped a 3 game losing streak last week with a 30-17 win at home vs NE, while CAR was at home & favored vs Dallas, but dropped their 4th straight game as they only put up 235 yds and allowed 6 sks in a 30-14 loss. At 7-7 ARZ is one game out of the NFC West lead and need to keep winning, while CAR has nothing left to play for. QB Murray is hitting 69% over the L/4 games and his favorite target is TE McBride and he leads the team with 89 rec and 938 yds. ARZ can also run the ball (163, 5.1 last week) and they face a CAR run D that has allowed 205 rush ypg (6.1) over the L/4 games. ARZ does have issues vs the pass, allowing 75% and 213 ypg the L/4 games but CAR has failed to top 200 yards in each of the L/2 games and are hitting just 59% over their L/4 games. We feel like ARZ is the better team with more to play for and they cover here. **BUFFALO by 17 over New England** - Buffalo enters this AFC East matchup off of a big win in DET where they put up 559 yards incl 362 pass yards by QB Allen. NE dropped their 4th straight game last week at ARZ, losing 30-17 and they sit at just 3-11 on the season. NE's pass D is allowing 236

ypg and 68% the L/4 games and Allen has a 25-5 ratio overall. Over the L/3 games Allen has a 7-0 ratio passing and also 6 rush td's. The Bills D has allowed 457 yds and 521 yds the L/2 games, but that was against two potent offenses. Here they face a Pats offense getting held to 43 ypg under what their foes allow (#29) and the Pats are putting up just 268 ypg/15 ppg on the road while BUF is +87 ypg/+17 ppg at home. This line is around 2 td's, but the Bills offense is rolling now and their defense will shut down NE & BUF wins by over 2 td's.

ATL does face a weak NYG offense (263 ypg/13 ppg the L/4 gms) and they have allowed just 317 ypg the L/4 gms. ATL has also gotten their pass rush going (13 sks L/3 gms) but their lack of offense will prevent them from pulling away.

INDIANAPOLIS by 7 over Tennessee - IND is off a tough loss at DEN where they looked to go up 20-7 3Q but a costly error by RB Taylor flipped the game and Indy lost 31-13 (won 5★ NFL GOY on DEN!). TEN is off a 37-27 loss to Cincy where they committed 6 TO's and they are #30 in the NFL with a -13 TO margin. TEN is going back to QB Rudolph after Levis threw 3 more int's last week. So Indy's pass D (70%, 224 ypg) won't really get tested. Indy QB Richardson once again shows flashes of talent, but is hitting just 47% with a 7-11 ratio and had 2 more int's last week. TEN's defense allowed 370 yds and 37 pts last week and a few weeks prior allowed 463 yds and 42 pts to WAS. TEN's pass D has allowed 72% the L/4 games and the Colts do have a talented WR group. At home we like the Colts to grab the win and they are laying just over a fg.

MINNESOTA by 10 over Seattle - SEA's 4 game win streak was snapped last week at home on SUN night where they lost 30-13 to GB. QB Smith left last week's game with a leg injury and is ? to play. Sam Howell is the backup for SEA if Smith (3623, 70%, 14-13) can't go. SEA has also missed RB Walker the past 2 games & overall SEA has been held to under 300 yards in 5 of their L/7 games. SEA's pass D (66%, 214 ypg) will face a tough test here as MIN is avg'g 267 pass ypg (67%) the L/4 games and SEA just allowed 229 pass (74%) last week. MIN also has a strong D that can rush the passer (42 sks) and SEA allowed 7 sacks last week. With SEA's offense struggling to move the ball, and MIN's offense rolling we feel like the Vikings are the superior team and will win here by double digits.

MIAMI by 3 over San Francisco - Miami's playoff hopes to a major hit last Sun with their loss at HOU where QB Tagovailoa threw 3 int's and the offense only put up 224 yards and 12 points. SF is all but out of a playoff spot as well with their loss to the Rams last Thur and they have dropped 4 of their L/5 games. SF does have extra rest traveling East but they are a beat up offense that has failed to topp 280 yards in 4 of their L/5 games. Miami's offense is better at home and they avg 250 pass ypg (70%) at home. MIA's defense allows just 309 ypg and have held 7 of their L/8 foes to under 100 rush yards and they have 7 sacks the past 2 weeks. It is tough however to lean with either team given there is not a lot to play for on either side, but at home we'll give MIA a small lean.

Jacksonville by 3 over LAS VEGAS - Las Vegas has now dropped 10 straight games and have the worst record in the AFC. JAX isn't far behind with just 3 wins but they have played competitive football the past few weeks. The offense put up 421 yds and 25 pts last week vs the Jets, while Vegas managed just 9 pts and 249 yds last Mon vs ATL. The Raiders D is actually solid, allowing just 330 ypg and their run D allows just 121 (4.4). JAX's run D is okay (132, 4.4) but struggle to stop the pass (264 pass ypg all'd, 69%) but the Raiders are on their 3rd QB. It is tough to lean with either team here, but the Raiders appear to be in full tank mode while JAX has shown signs of life the last few games and have a more potent offense so we'll lean them.

New Orleans vs GREEN BAY - MNF - The Packers come into this MON night game having won 4 of their L/5 games and are off a 30-13 win in SEA where they allowed just 208 yds and recorded 7 sacks. The Saints did show life last Sun at home vs WAS as they battled back from 10 pts down to score a late td but missed the 2-pt try that would have won them the game. At home GB is +85 ypg and their defense allows just 298 ypg at home while the Saints have failed to top 300 yards each of their L/2 games. NOLA may still be w/o QB Carr and they are dealing with several inj's overall. However their D is allowing just 324 ypg over the L/3 games.
