The only prior meeting came in 1965 when Navy won 10-0. Brent Venables is 0-2 SU/1-1 ATS in bowls. Navy is playing in their first bowl since '19 when they beat Kansas ST and they have covered their last 6 bowls but this is their first under HC Newberry. Navy is 1-1 in the Armed Forces Bowl, having won in '13 but lost in '16.

OK moved to the SEC this year. They started 3-0 in non-conf play including a 34-19 win over Tulane. Their offense struggled in SEC play and QB Arnold was benched in the 2H of their loss to Tenn. They were outgained 482-291 by Aub but won thanks to a late Pick-6 then had lopsided losses to Texas and SCar. QB Arnold was back as starter and OK led at half at Ole Miss. They were 5-5 when they hosted Bama and got 2 pick-6's and held a 325-234 yd edge, winning 24-3 then lost at LSU 37-17 in the finale. QB Arnold went in the portal so Michael Hawkins (63%, 1-2, 143 rush) is back as starter. They will likely be w/o their #1 rusher, 3 of their top 4 receivers, AA LB Danny Stutsman and All-SEC S Billy Bowman. The Sooners still have a stout D that allows just 106 rush (2.9) and holds foes 97 ypg below their avg.

Navy brought in former Mercer HC Drew Cronin as OC. The Middies started 6-0 including a win over Memphis. They were -6 TO's in a 51-14 loss to Notre Dame then caught Rice in a coaching change and lost 24-10. Navy's 28-7 win at USF set up our College 5★ GOY where we went against the Middies and they lost 35-0, held to 113 yards. Navy rebounded with a win at EC then upset Army. Navy is +12 ypg but has only played our #113 sked. QB Horvath has a 13-4 ratio and has rushed for over 1,000 yds.

OK is a small favorite but has some big edges. The Sooners have played a much tougher sked (#8 vs #113) and also has a huge ST's edge (#33 vs #112). We expect Venables to have a solid plan with extra time to prep and our checklist has OK by 9!

Only prior meeting was in 1979 where Syracuse won 52-25. Syracuse made a bowl under 1st year HC Brown and this is their 3rd straight season making a bowl. Wash St missed on a bowl game last season but are back in one this season, however will be without several players and coaches who have left for other schools.

'Cuse brought back 14 str's and added QB McCord from Ohio St. 'Cuse started 2-0 then were upset at home vs Stanford. They got 3 straight wins to get to 5-1 but then dropped 2 of the next 3. 'Cuse ended strong with 3 straight wins incl an upset of Mia, FL at home to end with 9 wins. McCord led all FBS QB's with 4,326 yards. 'Cuse has no major opt outs on offense so they will have a big edge at receiver with Meeks, Pena and Gadsden. 'Cuse held foes to 16 ypg under their avg (#62) but their pass D did struggle at times this season, finishing #105 and they are missing a starting CB.

WSU only returned 10 starters entering '24 and were without a conference with the Pac-12 breaking up. WSU started 4-0 incl wins over Tex Tech and Wash but then at Boise lost by 21. They won their next 4 games to get to 8-1 but dropped their final 3 games to finish 8-4. WSU will be w/o their QB, top RB, #2 WR and their starting RT. On defense WSU allowed foes to gain 26 ypg above their season avg (#101). They will be without both starting DT's, their #1 tackler at LB, along with 3 starters in the secondary. WSU will also be without their HC, OC and DC who all left for other jobs, so the DT's coach will be the interim HC here.

The line in this game is around 17, which is where the checklist has this game. However will WSU barely being able to field a team and 'Cuse having a great year, they will be motivated to get to 10 wins and end a successful year 1 under HC Fran Brown. We do think 'Cuse is the much better team but with the line being so large we will limit ourselves to a 2-star play.

USC is 3-0 all-time vs Texas A&M but they haven't met since 1977. A&M is playing in their first Vegas Bowl. Mike Elko won his only bowl at Duke vs UCF two years ago. Lincoln Riley is 2-4 SU/3-3 AT'S in Bowl. Last year they were w/o Caleb Williams but still beat L'ville 42-28 (+7). USC is 1-1 SU/ATS in Vegas Bowls.

Mike Elko inherited a talented roster at A&M. They lost their opener to Notre Dame then rattled off 7 straight wins including at Florida 33-17 and at home over Missouri 41-10 and LSU 38-23. QB Marcel Reed took over in the 2H of that win over the Tigers and led a comeback. They lost 3 of their last 4 including at SCar and at Auburn. They had a chance to still make the SEC Title game but was outgained 458-248 and lost to Texas by 10. The Aggies are +38 ypg. Their D is allowing 365 ypg and holds foes 33 ypg below their avg but will be w/o 3 starters on D including AA DE Nic Scourton. In their last 4 SEC games Texas allowed 472 ypg.

Lincoln Riley lost key players from last year including #1DC QB Caleb Williams but that team only went 8-5. USC beat LSU in the opener and was 2-0. They led Mich in the Big House 24-20 but lost after a long td run late. USC trailed Wisky at half but won by 17. The Trojans lost 3 straight, all by 7 or less including a 2OT loss to Penn St. They won 3 of their next 4 with the loss coming by just 5 points at Wash. They were 6-5 when they hosted Notre Dame. USC put up a ssn high 557 yards but QB Maiava threw 91 & 99 yard IR td's. USC is +69 ypg and 5 of their losses came by 7 or less. They will be w/o their top 2 RB's, #2, #3 and #5 WR's and their RT.

Both teams have critical opt outs in this game but we think USC's are more replaceable. They have two talented RB's and their top 4 remaining WR's have still been more productive than A&M's top 4. A&M's D played worse late in the season and we trust that Riley will have a plan to pull the upset.

First meeting. BC is 0-2 SU/ATS in the Pinstripe Bowl, having lost in '14 & '17. The Eagles are in a bowl for the 2nd straight ssn and did beat SMU in the Fenway Bowl last year. This is Bill O'Brien's first bowl. Nebraska is traveling 1400 miles to play in Yankee Stadium for the first time. Huskers fans will be fired up for their first bowl in 8 years! Matt Rhule is 1-2 SU/ATS in bowl games.

BC opened '24 by upsetting FSU in Ireland and they started 4-1 but with FSU finishing 2-10 this year, none of those wins were impressive. They led UVA 14-0 2Q but lost by 10 then trailed VT 28-0 before a rally and were within 7 then lost by 21. BC's losing streak reached 3 games vs L'ville. QB Castellanos was benched in their win over Cuse then went in the Portal and Grayson James led the Eagles to wins in 3 of their last 4 to reach 7-5 and +7 ypg. Ezeiruaku led the ACC with 16.5 sacks and is the ACC DEF POY and is on the bowl depth chart. James played well in their last two games, hitting 69% with a 3-0 ratio.

Neb was much more exp'd in Matt Rhule's 2nd year and added true frosh phenom QB Raiola. The Huskers started 3-0 including a dominant win over Colorado. They lost in OT to Illinois and were 5-1 after beating Pur and Rut. The Huskers were slaughtered by Indiana then had close losses to Ohio St, UCLA and USC. They finally got their 6th win at home against Wisc 44-25 and finished 6-6. Their Dline is the strength, allowing just 106 rush ypg (3.5). The Huskers D allows just 315 ypg and holds foes 59 ypg below their avg (#25 in FBS).

BC has an excellent Oline but they will have a tough time against Nebraska's stout Dline. BC is +7 ypg while Neb is +42 and ply'd a tougher sked. Our checklist has BC by 1.5 and they are the dog but we don't think Ezeiruaku plays which would give Neb a big edge and we think they will be fired up to clinch a winning season.

FORECAST: NEBRASKA RATING: 2★

First meeting. LA is in a bowl for the 7th straight season, but have lost their last 2 bowl games & their last bowl win was in 2021 against Marshall in the NOLA Bowl. TCU missed a bowl last season after making it to the national title game back in 2022. This is only TCU's 2 bowl since 2019. HC Dykes is 2-4 SU/3-3 ATS in bowls.

LA returned 15 starters and this looked to be HC Desormeaux's best team. LA started 2-0 then played Tulane close (had yds edge). From that point the Cajuns won 6 straight games to get to 8-1. They fell behind 24-0 vs SAla and lost by 2 pts but then won their L/2 reg ssn games to get to the SBC title. They hosted Marshall, but lost backup QB Fields (Wooldridge was out vs SAla) and lost 31-3. Wooldridge could be back for this game, but if it's not him it'll be 3rd string QB Daniel Beale. They are also without their #3 RB and #2 and #3 receivers. On defense the Cajuns held foes to 18 ypg under their avg (#60) but did play a lighter schedule. Their pass D ranked #68 but could be w/o a starting S & their #2 tk'r is out.

TCU was off a disappointing 2023 season, and returned 16 st'rs this season. They started out 2-0, but then dropped 3 of their next 4 games after losing at home vs Houston. From that point TCU won 5 of their final 6 games then end the season 8-4. QB Hoover had a solid season (67%, 23-10 ratio) and TCU had 4 WR's all top 600 yards. However they will be without WR's Bech and Williams here along with #1 RB Cook. TCU is also without their starting C. ON defense TCU did hold foes to 14 ypg under their avg (#60) and the pass D was strong (#29, 59%, 14-8) but did allow 164 rush ypg and they don't have any major opt outs on this side of the ball.

Army has won both prior meetings in '08 and '13. LT is traveling just 69 miles to play in the Independence Bowl for the 6th time (3-1-1 SU in this bowl). Army was supposed to play in this Bowl in '20 but the game was cancelled. Sonny Cumbie won his only prior bowl as Interim HC at Texas Tech. Army is 7-3 SU all-time in Bowls including 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS under HC Monken. Their last bowl was an upset win over Mizzou in '21.

LA Tech only went 5-7 this year but is +1 ppg and +42 ypg. They replaced Marshall after they backed out when a bulk of their roster hit the Portal following Coach Huff's departure. LT's best win came at WKU and 3 of their losses did come in OT. Their D is allowing just 302 ypg/20 ppg and they hold foes 51 ypg under their avg but they will be w/o 1st Tm CUSA DT David Blay (#5 tkl'r) who led with 6.5 sks. QB Evan Bullock is hitting 67% with a 14-2 ratio.

Army moved to the AAC this year and started 9-0 but only 2 of those wins were over Bowl teams (EC & NT). They were no match for Notre Dame in a 49-14 loss. They did beat a solid UTSA squad then upset Tulane 35-14 in the AAC Title Game for the first Conference Title in Army History! Army was upset the following week by rival Navy. They are 11-2 and +15 ppg/+77 ypg. They did lose 1,000 RB Udoh to the Portal but Bryson Daily makes this offense go (942 pass, 1532 rush) and the Oline is a strength (299, 5.6). Army's D only allows 304 ypg and is holding their foes 97 ypg below their avg which is #3 in the FBS!

LT hasn't faced the option this year and they don't get as much prep time after only getting in this bowl a week ago. Not only do the Bulldogs have to regroup after ending the season, but now they have to face a triple option offense that they haven't seen all year. LT is 5-0 as dogs but Army has dominated their weaker foes, with 9 of their 11 wins by 17 or more so we don't mind laying over 2 td's here.

FORECAST: ARMY **RATING: 4★**

Last met in the 2010 Insight Bowl with Iowa winning 27-24. These teams were supposed to meet in this exact bowl back in 2020 but it was cancelled due to covid. This is the 21st bowl for Iowa HC Ferentz here & he has a record of 10-10 SU/12-7-1 ATS. Iowa played here in '22 & beat Kentucky 21-0. Mizzou is in a bowl for a 4th straight season and last season beat Ohio St 14-3 in the Cotton Bowl.

Iowa started 3-1 with their only loss coming to Iowa St on a last second fg. At Ohio St they only trailed 7-0 HT but fell behind and lost 35-7. They hosted Wash and won 40-16 then at Mich St were upset. Iowa went on to win 4 of their L/5 games, with the lone loss coming at UCLA. Iowa was led by star RB Kaleb Johnson (1537, 6.4, 21 td) but he is not playing here. QB McNamara went in the portal, so it will be Brendan Sullivan starting. Iowa's OL only allowed 15 sks and paved the way for 200 ypg (5.2). On defense Iowa held foes to 40 ypg under their season avg (#42) and the run defense only gave up 118 (3.8). Iowa also has a strong pass D (#32) but they have a starting CB who is not playing here.

Mizzou brought back 14 starters this season from their 11-2 season a year ago. The Tigers opened up 4-0 but didn't have an impressive win before they lost to Tex A&M on the road 41-10. They won their next 2 games but then were shutout 34-0 at Bama then after a win vs Okla they nearly upset S.Car on the road (34-30 loss). Mizzou ended with 2 wins to finish 9-3. Mizzou with have QB Cook and WR Wease, but won't have WR's Burden and Cooper along with TE Norfleet (#2, #3, #4 receivers). Mizzou will also be without their starting RT. On defense Mizzou held foes to 46 ypg under their avg (#34) and their pass D ranks #69.

Iowa has a big ST's edge (#15 vs #91) and they are the more physical team and have the coaching edge. Plus Mizzou is missing several key skill players. Iowa is the dog but we like them outright!

FORECAST: IOWA **RATING: 4★**

This is a rematch of last year's CFB Semifinal game won by Michigan 27-20 (+2). The Tide are in a bowl for the 21st straight year. This is also a revenge game for Kalen DeBoer who lost the Nat'l Title to Michigan last year as HC at Washington. DeBoer is 2-1 SU/ATS in bowls while this is HC Moore's first bowl. Prior to LY Mich had lost 6 straight bowls both SU & ATS.

Kalen DeBoer had the world's largest shoes to fill when he took over for Nick Saban. He had a talented roster returning including QB Jalen Milroe and brought over key transfers from Washington. Bama opened 4-0 including their win over Georgia but was stunned by Vandy the following week. They pulled out a 2 pt win over SCar and led Tenn 17-14 4Q but lost by 4. Bama crushed Mizzou and LSU but crushed their playoffs hopes by putting up just 3 points and 234 yds vs OK. The Tide won the Iron Bowl to finish 9-3 and +92 ypg but only +18 vs the SEC. QB Milroe says he is playing so the offense is mostly in tact. They will be missing 3 starters on D due to injuries but still have plenty of depth and held foes 77 ypg below their avg. Bama should have the crowd edge as well.

There was no way Sherrone Moore could match last year's Nat'l Title season. Mich only had 7 starters back and major ? at QB. They lost by 19 at home to Texas but were 4-1 with wins over USC and Minn. Mich lost their first 2 road games at Wash and Ill. They were 5-4 when they outplayed Indiana in the 2H but lost 20-15. Mich dominated NW before upsetting Ohio St 13-10. Mich has an excellent D, allowing just 311 ypg but are likely w/o 3 key starters who are opting out. Their offense avg just 294 ypg and puts up 32 ypg less than their foes allow.

No question Bama has a huge edge on offense and the revenge factor in their favor. Mich is 2-1 ATS as a DD dog this year but our checklist gives Bama a small edge so we will roll with the Tide.

UGA has won all 3 prior meetings but the two recent wins only came by 7 combined points in '17 & '19. ND is in the CFP for the 3rd time and picked up their first ever playoff win last week against Indiana in a misleading 27-17 final. The Irish led that game 27-3 and gave up 2 td's in the final 2 minutes. Freeman is now 3-1 SU/ATS in post ssn gms.

ND entered '24 returning 15 starters back and added QB Riley Leonard from Duke. ND upset Tex A&M in the opener but then lost to NIU the next game. They responded by winning their next 10 regular season games by an avg of 31 pts. Their only win by single-digits was vs L'ville. ND used big plays last week vs Indiana including a 98 yd td run by Jeremiah Love. Leonard is hitting 66% (2293, 17-6) and was also the #2 rusher (751, 5.6, 15 td). ND's top 4 RB's totaled 1,938 yds (7.1, 335 rec) but the top 4 receivers had just 1,366 yds (11.7). ND's OL has allowed just 17 sks. ND's D is allowing 295 ypg and holds foes 88 ypg below their avg. S Xavier Watts is an All-American but ND will be without their top DT, Rylie Mills who was injured vs Indiana.

UGA opened '24 with a 34-3 win over Clemson but struggled on the road, only beating KY by 1 then lost at Bama despite a furious 2H comeback. The Dawgs won their next 4 including at Texas where they dominated the 1H (23-0, 178-38 yds). They were held to a ssn low 245 yds and 10 pts at Ole Miss and lost by 18 but rebounded with a 31-17 win over Tenn. With the SEC Title game on deck, the Dawgs needed 8 OT's to beat G'Tech. They lost QB Beck in the SEC Title game but won 22-19. They are 11-2 and +77 ypg and have 4 wins over teams that made the playoffs.

QB Gunner Stockton struggled vs Texas but should be much better after getting 1st team reps. The Dawgs have played a much tougher sked (#4 vs #47) and a big ST's edge (#4 vs #61) with ND's kickers hitting just 10-21 this season. UGA's Peyton Woodring (20-22, L/55) will be the difference in a Dawgs win.

First meeting. Ole Miss is 2-2 SU/ATS in bowls under Kiffin. They were +5' LY in the Peach Bowl vs Penn St and won 38-25. Ole Miss is 1-2 in the Gator Bowl but this is their first trip here since 1991. Manny Diaz was 1-1 SU/O-2 ATS in bowls at Miami. Duke has covered their last 7 bowls (4-3 SU). Duke is making their first trip to the Gator Bowl.

Ole Miss entered '24 as a playoff contender with QB Jaxson Dart returning. They had a light early schedule and started 4-0 but were upset by KY. They beat SCar 27-3 and were the better team vs LSU but lost in OT. Ole Miss won their next 3 games including an impressive 28-10 win over Georgia where they had a 397-245 yd edge. The Rebels were a lock to make the playoffs if they won out but they tripped up at Florida. Ole Miss won the Egg Bowl to finish 9-3 and are +208 ypg. QB Dart has a 25-6 ratio. Their D allows just 314 ypg and they lead the FBS with 52 sacks!

Duke HC Manny Diaz made a splash by adding Texas transfer QB Maalik Murphy. The Blue Devil started 5-0 thanks to an OT win over NW and they rallied from down 20-0 at half vs NC and won by 1. Duke lost 24-14 at G'Tech then put up just 180 yds vs FSU but won because of TO's. Duke was +6 TO's but lost to SMU by 1. They led Miami 28-17 3Q but lost by 22. Duke won their last 3 to finish 9-3 but are -3 ypg. QB Murphy went in the Portal. Henry Belin started 1 game last year and did have an 8-4 ratio but faces a stiff test against a physical Ole Miss D. Duke's D allows 344 ypg and they do have 41 sacks while their Oline has allowed just 12.

Ole Miss is +208 ypg and has had the yards edge in every game while Duke is -3 ypg vs a similar sked strength. Ole Miss has a big edge on offense and they should be fired up to prove they belonged in the playoff field. Duke did it with smoke & mirrors all year so we don't mind laying over 2 td's with Ole Miss.

LAR is 13-3 SU/ATS since 2017 vs the Cardinals and now face a Cardinals team off an emotional OT loss at Carolina where they were eliminated from playoff contention. NE did play Buffalo tough last week on the road, losing 24-21 and they had a 379-324 yard edge. The Chargers are off extra rest, as they played at home last Thur vs DEN and came back to win 34-27. NE's OL has allowed 47 sacks and face a Chargers pass rush that has 42 sacks on the season. QB Herbert hit 74% with a 2-1 ratio last week and overall is hitting 65% with an 18-3 ratio and the Patriots allow 66% completions. The Chargers found something on offense in that 2H last week. The temps will be in the 50's but there is a chance of rain. Harbaugh will have the Chargers defense ready to roll and will make life tough for rookie QB Maye plus QB Herbert will be on his A game.

OTHER PLAYS

Seattle vs CHICAGO - Thursday - Seattle has now lost 2 straight after losing at home B2B weeks to GB and MIN. QB Smith had 314 pass yards and threw 3 td's but also threw 2 costly int's and SEA only ran for 59 total yards. The Bears have now dropped 9 straight games after last week's 34-17 loss against DET at home. The Bears defense allowed 475 yards and 27 fd's, while the offense was led by QB Williams 334 pass yards but he was also the leading rusher with just 34 yards. The Bears D has allowed 423 ypg/31 ppg including 282 pass ypg. SEA QB Smith is #3 in the NFL in passing (3937 yards) and WR's Metcalf and Smith-Njigba should each have big days. SEA needs to win their last 2 games and get some help to win the NFC West, while the Bears have nothing left to play for. **Call the office on Thur after Noon EST for the Marquee Winner!**

CINCINNATI by 7 over Denver - Saturday - Cincy needs to win each of their last 2 games and still get some help in order to reach the playoffs. DEN makes the trek out East after blowing a 24-13 lead vs the Chargers last Thur. DEN's pass D allowed 263 yards last week and 475 vs CLE and 300 vs Vegas and now face QB Burrow who is #1 in the NFL in pass yards (4,229) and are tied for the NFL lead with 39 td passes. Burrow has thrown for at least 3 td's in each of the last 7 games. Bo Nix has been up and down the last few games and Denver's offense was shut down in the 2H last week. DEN can still win their last game and make the playoffs so this is not a necessary game for them to have, while Cincy needs this one & at home we side with the Bengals.

Indianapolis by 10 NY GIANTS - The Giants have now lost 10 straight games and the last 2 games have been blowout losses by 21 and 27 points and the offense is putting up just 257 ypg and 12 ppg the last 5 games. The Colts put up 458 yards incl 218 rush yards from RB Taylor last week and QB Richardson had 70 rush yds and only threw the ball 11 times. The Giants DLine has been worn down over the season as they have just 6 sacks the L7 games after recording 35 sacks the first 8 games. The Giants pass D does allow 70% so Richardson could have some success throwing, but we expect Indy to be able to run the ball strong again and beat down a Giants team that has its eyes set on the #1 pick in the draft.

Las Vegas by 3 over NEW ORLEANS - Derek Carr likely won't be facing his old team here and the Saints QB situation behind him is rough. The Saints could also be without RB Kamara again and they have been losing skill position players left and right. The last 3 games NOLA has put up 244 ypg/11 ppg and the run game has been non-existent. The Raiders broke their 10 game losing streak last week with a 19-14 win against JAX where QB O'Connell returned and threw for 257 yards. The Saints are off a 34-0 loss on the road on MON night and now are on a short week with nothing left to play for. This will not be a pretty game by any means, but the Raiders showed some signs of life last week while the Saints are thin at several positions.

JACKSONVILLE by 3 over Tennessee - Two of the NFL's worst teams faceoff here as both teams just have 3 wins. Tennessee has dropped 4 in a row and just lost at Indy 38-30 where they gave up 335 rush yards (6.7) and 458 yds overall. TEN is a league-worst 2-12-1 ATS and have covered just 1 of their last 7 games. JAX has lost 7 of their last 8 games, but 6 of those losses were by 7 points or less and they are actually +20 ypg the L4 games while TEN is -96 ypg the past 4 games. While JAX is going with Mac Jones as the QB, he faces a TEN defense allowing 74% completions the past 4 games and their run defense is struggling. JAX's defense is only allowing 328 ypg over the past 4 games, so we will lean with the home team here.

BUFFALO by 13 over NY Jets - The Jets nightmare season is almost over, as they sit at 4-11 with 2 games left and lost last week at home to the Rams despite having a 321-242 yard edge. Buffalo did manage to get past NE last week, but that is an upstart Patriots team with a rookie QB looking to prove himself, while the Jets are full of veterans and they are underperforming. Buffalo already beat the Jets once this season, and now the Bills get them at home where they are 7-0 SU this season, winning by an avg of 15 ppg. The Jets are -52 ypg on the road and allow 366 ypg on the road while the Bills only allow 293 ypg at home. The Jets are missing some of their key players on defense and might be misng them here. While the Bills can't get the #1 seed, they still are trying to fine tune things and the Jets are just waiting for the season to end.

TAMPA BAY by 7 over Carolina - Tampa Bay had their 4 game win streak snapped last week on MON night against the Cowboys and are once again tied with ATL for the NFC South lead. Carolina has been a scrappy team of late and just knocked Arizona out of playoff contention with a 36-30 OT win and they have 3 pt losses against TB and KC and a 6-pt loss to Philly. CAR did run the ball well last week (243, 6.8) but the Bucs are allowing just 58 rush ypg (3.0) the last 4 games, is is their pass D that is struggling as they are allowing 80%!! the past 4 games and 236 pass ypg. The Panthers pass D has been hit for big plays and in their earlier matchup allowed 209 pass yds but were gashed on the ground for 236 (6.1). We think TB wins this game but CAR

However the Dolphins pass offense is avg'g 264 ypg (73%) the last 4 games and the run game actually showed life last week, rushing for 166 yds (5.5). The Browns are #1 in the NFL allowing 63 sacks and Miami has 10 sacks the past 3 games. CLE 2nd year QB Thompson-Robinson looked lost last week and he'll be under constant pressure.
