NT is back in a bowl after missing one last season. This is the 1st bowl for HC Morris, but he also has FCS playoff experience at Incarnate Word. NTex only returned 11 starters entering '24, but they did add TCU transfer QB Chandler Morris. They started 2-0 incl a win at SALA but then were blown out 66-21 at Tex Tech. After that they won 3 straight incl a 27 pt win vs Wyo and a 32 pt win vs Tulsa. NT then lost 5 straight games as their defense couldn't stop teams. They won their last game at Temple by 7 pts to get their 6th win and get to a bowl. QB Morris finished with 3,774 yards and had a 31-12 ratio but he will not be playing here along with NT's top WR. True frosh QB Mestemaker will be starting. On defense NT allowed foes to gain 75 ypg above their avg (#124) and their pass D ranks #103. TXSt entered '24 with hopes to win the Sun Belt (18 str's back) and they added JMU QB McCloud. TXSt started 2-0 but then dropped 2 close games to Ariz St and Sam Houston. They opened 2-0 SBC play then lost at ODU and to Louisiana. They finished the season 3-1 but did lose at home to GA State. QB McCloud had a 29-12 ratio but won't play significant snaps here and bkp Martinez is in the portal so Brad Jackson would likely get the majority of the reps. They will also be without RB Mahdi. TXSt's top WR's are playing though. On defense TXSt held foes to 32 ypg under their avg but will be without a starting CB and 2 starting DT's. The line for this game is approaching 2 td's in favor of Texas St, but we think that is a lot of points, especially if TXSt QB McCloud plays limited snaps. NT does struggle on defense and TXSt should still move the ball, but they are missing a few str's on defense. This should be a high scoring game & we'll go with the 'Over'

First meeting. This is VT's 3rd trip to this Bowl game. They won here in '16 over Arkansas but lost to Kentucky in '19 when this was known as The Belk Bowl. PJ Fleck has won all 5 bowl games as HC at Minnesota (4-1 ATS). Brent Pry is 1-0 SU/ATS in bowls here, having won & covered in the Military Bowl vs Tulane last year. PJ Fleck had 16 starters back from LY's 6 win team. QB Max Brosmer transferred in from New Hampshire. The Gophers missed a GW fg vs NC in the opener. They had B2B shutouts vs RI & Nev. They started 0-2 in B10 play, losing to Iowa & trailed Mich 24-3 but only lost by 3. Minn won 4 straight to get bowl elig including close wins over USC & UCLA, and a road upset over Illinois. The Gophers were held under 300 yards by both Rut & Penn St in losses by just 8 combined points. Minn upset Wisky 24-7 w/a 374-166 yd edge to finish 7-5. Minn is +41 ypg. QB Brosmer is hitting 67% with a 17-5 ratio. Their defense allows just 291 ypg and holds foes 76 ypg below their avg but their offense avg just 332 ypg and is putting up 28 ypg less than their foes allow. VT was one of the most experienced tms this ssn with 21 starters back including QB Kyron Drones. Their upset loss at Vandy in the opener doesn't look nearly as bad now. They beat Sun Belt Champs Marshall by 17 and were 2-1. They hosted Rutgers and trailed 23-7 but rallied late to force OT. VT nearly upset Miami then won their next 3 games. VT was 5-3 but lost 3 straight to Cuse, Clem & Duke. Their 6th win came over rival Virginia. VT puts up 380 ypg and is +20 ypg. Their D allows 360 ypg but they are holding foes 40 ypg below their avg. Lots of players are sitting this one out. Minn is out 2 All-Big 10 OL and a starting CB. VT is w/o QB Drones, 2 WR's, their LT and C, 2 All-ACC DL and 2 starting DB's. VT will have the crowd edge, but they are getting over a td so despite the opt outs we like the Hokies.

Lib is 3-0 SU in this series and they last met in '23 when the Flames were -3 on the road and won 55-27 with a 569-363 yd edge. Pete Lembo is 0-2 SU/ATS in bowls but those were back at Ball St. Buff has won their last 2 bowl trips including here in '19 when they beat CLT 31-9 (-6). Lib is making their first trip to the Bahamas. They've were 4-0 ATS in bowls until LY's blowout loss to Oregon in the Fiesta Bowl. Buff opened '24 3-1 including an upset win over Northern Illinois the week after the Huskies beat Notre Dame. The Bulls were outgained 359-184 by NIU then were crushed 47-3 by UConn, outgained 537-198. They upset Toledo for a 2-0 MAC start but lost to WMich and Ohio in their next 2. Buff ended on a 4 game winning streak despite getting outgained by Akron, Ball St and EMich. The only MAC win where they had a yardage edge was over lowly Kent St. Buff is -49 ypg. The Bulls LB's, Shaun Dolac (159 tkls) and Red Murdock (143 tkls) are #1 and #1 in the FBS but Buff's D allows 404 ypg and 68 ypg more than their foes avg. Lib went was 13-0 in the reg ssn last year and returned 14 starters this year including AA QB Kaidon Salter. Lib was underwhelming during a 5-0 start. They only beat NMSt by 6, trailed ECar 17-0 but won by 11 & only beat FIU by 7. They suffered one of the biggest upsets in CFB this year when they lost to Kennesaw St (-28) then lost a close game to Jax St. Lib won 3 straight and needed to beat SH to reach the CUSA Title game but only put up 262 yards and missed a 2 pt conv to tie the game. Lib is 8-3 and +85 ypg but are w/o many of their key players including QB Salter, RB Cooley, 3 str'g OL and their #2 tk'r. App St transfer Ryan Burger will start at QB. Despite the opt outs, our checklist still has Liberty by 1. The Flames are the underdog because of the opt outs and we feel Buffalo is taking this game more seriously, especially on defense with their 2 stud LB's playing. We like the Bulls by a td.

4★ Cincinnati over PITTSBURGH - Saturday - PIT has now dropped 3 straight against some of the top teams in the NFL (Philly, Bal, KC) and now catch a red-hot Cincy team that is riding a 4-game win streak and still hoping to reach the playoffs. Burrow has hit at least 70% in his last 5 games and has topped 250 pass yds and thrown at least 3 td's in his last 8 games. He threw for 309 yds and 3 td's in the last meeting and the Steelers are allowing 69% and 237 ypg over the L/4 gms. Cincy D has allowed just 325 ypg over the L/4 games and PIT has put up just 277 ypg/17 ppg pver their L/4 games. These two teams are headed in opposite directions and we'll side with the Bengals to get the win.

FORECAST: Cincinnati by 14

3★ Washington over DALLAS - WAS enters the final week of the regular season with 11 wins and a playoff spot locked up, but a win here would give WAS the #6 seed and a matchup with the Rams instead of the Eagles. It looks like Jayden Daniels will start here but there is no official word as of presstime, while there is some rumblings in Dallas that Cooper Rush may not play here due to contract incentives due and Trey Lance could see some or all of the snaps. This WAS team is gaining a ton of confidence and Dallas is off a horrible loss in Philly where the Eagles were down to their #3 QB but DAL lost 41-7 and were -4 TO's. DAL will also be without WR Lamb. We like WAS here as they have gained a ton of momentum of late, while the Cowboys have packed it in. We'll side with WAS here who would benefit from a win & they did lose to DAL earlier this season.

FORECAST: Washington by 14

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ DETROIT over Minnesota - SNF - The NFC north comes down to this Sunday night matchup at Ford Field. Detroit's defense has been banged up more and more as the season has gone along, but they still are finding ways to win. DET won 40-34 at SF last Mon despite allowing 475 yards (400 pass yds) as they were +2 TO's and the offense put up 439 yards. DET won a close game in Minn earlier this season. It is the only home game Minn lost all season. DET has put up 457 ypg/38 ppg over the L/4 games incl 342 pass ypg (72%). DET does shut down the run (97, 4.4) but their issue is their pass D (321 ypg, 68% the L/4 games) and Minn is throwing for 281 ypg (69%) the L/4 games. DET does a +9 TO difference this season and are +4 TO's the L/2 games. Powered by their strong offense and in front of their wild home crowd, we like the Lions to get the win here.

FORECAST: Detroit by 10

OTHER PLAYS

BALTIMORE by 20 over Cleveland - Saturday - BAL has already clinched a playoff berth, but still need a win here to clinch the AFC North and get a home playoff game. CLE is now tied for the worst record in the league and only managed 162 yards vs MIA at home last week & their offense the last 3 weeks has scored a total of 16 points. BAL is off a dominating 31-2 at HOU on Christmas where they held a 432-211 yd edge which included 251 rush (5.8). CLE does only allow 127 rush ypg (4.5) and in their last matchup, a win, held BAL to 124 rush. BAL does have a dilemma on their hands of whether to play or rest their starters. As of presstime it is unclear, but with the division not locked up yet, they should see some time here. CLE hasn't shown life lately on offense and could be starting ANOTHER new QB. The Ravens should win comfortably, but with the line inflated, we'll only lean slightly with Ravens.

TAMPA BAY by 17 over New Orleans - Tampa Bay needs a win here to lock up the NFC South after their 48-14 win vs Carolina where they had a 551-204 yd edge and QB Mayfield threw for 349 yds and 5 td's. The Saints have now dropped 3 straight and over their last 4 games the offense is putting up just 251 ypg/11 ppg. Over the last 4 games NOLA is -110 ypg/-12 ppg. TB's defense has allowed just 291 ypg over the L/7 games which includes just 60 rush ypg (3.2). Over the L/4 games TB is holding foes to 59 ypg under their avg and have 11 sacks. TB put up 594 and 51 pts in their last meeting, and with the Saints depleted on both sides of the ball, we feel like TB will take care of business here.

Buffalo by 4 over NEW ENGLAND - Buffalo has locked up the #2 seed in the AFC and cannot move up or down in the standings after their 40-14 win over the Jets last week. NE is off a 40-7 loss to the Chargers where they were outgained 428-181. Two weeks ago NE did put up 379 yards against the Bills but were -2 TO's. If the Buffalo starters play at all it likely won't be for long. As of now it looks like BUF QB Allen will start the game, but is unknown how long he'll play. NE proved they could hang with Buffalo a couple of weeks ago and with the Bills backups likely playing a good part of this game, but with the line under a fg we'll still lean BUF.

GREEN BAY by 7 over Chicago - GB comes into the final week with a playoff spot locked up, but are off a loss to MIN where they trailed 27-10 4Q before a pair of scores made the game look closer (27-25 loss). The Bears come into this gm having lost 10 straight and are off a 6-3 loss to SEA at home last Thur where they put up just 179 yards. In their last meeting CHI had a fg for the win but it was blocked. GB's offense was held to just 271 yds last week, but their defense is holding foes to 23 ypg under their avg (#5). The Packers are locked into either the #6 or #7 seed but getting the #6 seed would avoid a 1st round matchup with PHI. Like the other games, if GB's starters play it may not be for long and we still like GB to get the win, but the spread is at DD's now.

Miami by 6 over NY JETS - Miami is entering week 18 with a chance to reach the playoffs but they need a win here plus a loss by Denver. Miami was without QB Tagovailoa last week in CLE but that wasn't an issue as they beat the Browns 20-3 as QB Huntley was 22-26 for 206 yds. It looks like Huntley will be getting the start again, but MIA is going up against weak NYJ team that is just 4-12 and has won just 2 of their last 13 games. NYJ QB Rodgers is sitting on 499 career td passes but the Jets offense has been subpar all season and the Dolphins only allow 311 ypg and have held 2 of their last 3 foes to under 300 yds. With MIA having a lot to play for still and their kicking off at the same time as DEN, they will be trying to win, so we like the Dolphins here.

DENVER by 7 over Kansas City - KC will be resting a lot of their starters here, which benefits Denver who needs a win to reach the playoffs. Denver came close to beating KC earlier this season in Arrowhead as they had their GW field goal attempt blocked and lost 16-14. DEN has lost 2 close games in a row to LAC and Cincy, but are fortunate here to go against the KC backups. DEN does have a great pass rush (58 sacks on the season) and they had 7 sacks last week & the KC offensive tackle situation has been an issue at times and it will be QB Wentz likely getting the start for KC, but he has experience. DEN QB Nix did throw for 215 last time vs KC and has hit 65% with a 25-12 ratio and is coming off a game where he hit 77% and had a 3-1 ratio. KC does still have a talented roster even with backups playing and we think this is a one-score game.

La Chargers by 6 over LAS VEGAS - The Chargers clinched a playoff spot last week with a dominant 40-7 win against New England where they had a 428-181 yd edge and QB Herbert threw for 3 td's and 281 yards. Whether starters play or not could be determined by how Saturday's games go. If PIT loses the Chargers would have a shot at the #5 seed. If Herbert doesn't play it would be Taylor Heinicke or Easton Stick at QB. Vegas has won 2 straight games, but that was against Jacksonville and New Orleans. These teams met in Week 1 and LAC won 22-10 but this is a completely different Raiders team now than in week 1. If the starters play for LAC, we like the Chargers, but if it's the backups we'd probably have the game right around the line.

INDIANAPOLIS by 6 over Jacksonville - Neither team has anything to play for here. JAX is off a win against TEN while the Colts were beat by the Giants last week. IND was without QB Richardson and backup QB Flacco threw for 330 yards and 2 td's but also threw 2 int's. RB Taylor also ran for 125 yds and a td. One of JAX's 4 wins this season came against the Colts earlier this season 37-34 where Flacco was also the starter. It is unknown whether IND QB Richardson will play here. The Jags would probably benefit from losing this game to improve their draft position and the Colts have shown some life and we think they'll end the season with a win.

ATLANTA by 14 over Carolina - Atlanta needs a win here and TB to lose to NOLA to get into the playoffs after the Falcons lost 30-24 in OT at Wash on Sunday night. CAR had been competitive in their recent games, but last week at TB were blown out 48-14 and were outgained 551-204. ATL does run the ball well (145, 4.6 L/4 gms) and the Panthers are allowing 207 ypg (6.0) the last 4 games and their pass D is also allowing 69% completions the last 4 games & last week gave up 349 yds and 5 td passes. ATL did dominate the first meeting, winning 38-20 with an 88 yd edge. ATL's offense does look much different with a more mobile QB under center that can move around the pocket and make plays with his feet. The Falcons kickoff at the same time as TB so they will be playing all-out here. We'll take ATL by 2 td's.

Seattle by 3 over LA Rams - LA Rams locked up the Division with a win last week against Arizona. Seattle can no longer reach the playoffs and are off a 6-3 win in CHI last Thur. The Rams will start Jimmy Garoppolo and several of their starters will see limited or no playing time as HC McVay hinted at giving some of his guys rest with a playoff spot locked up. The Rams defense has been stellar of late, allowing just 24 points total the L/3 games and just 303 ypg. SEA's offense has been less potent as the season has gone on, putting up under 300 yards in 5 of their L/7 games and the OL has allowed 52 sacks overall incl 12 the L/3 games. SEA has only allowed 301 ypg the L/4 games and with the Rams resting starters we'll call for SEA by a fg.

ARIZONA by 7 over San Francisco - Neither team is playin' for anything here. Arizona put up a solid effort at the LA Rams last Sat, and had a 396-257 yd edge but were -2 TO's. ARZ though has lost 5 of their L/6 games, as have the 49ers. With SF QB Purdy dealing with several nagging inj's, Josh Dobbs will start for SF on Sunday. As of now it looks like Kyle Murray will start for Arizona and they have no major starters sitting in this game. Arizona won the earlier meeting against SF on the road, but SF is one of the most banged up teams in the NFL this season and they will be without several key players, so we like the Cardinals to get the win/cover here.

Houston by 3 over TENNESSEE - HOU is locked into the #4 seed so there is not much left to play for and it is unclear on how or/iff QB Stroud and other starters will play. Tennessee has now dropped 5 straight games and are just 3-13 on the season and are a league-worst 2-13-1 ATS this season. Tenn did beat Houston earlier this season, and the Texans do want to go into the playoffs with some momentum. Houston has dropped their L/2 games, but that was against KC and BAL and the offense needs to find some rhythm (avg/g just 257 ypg/16 ppg the L/4 games). The Texans are actually the dog here, but we like them to come away with the win.

PHILADELPHIA by 6 over NY Giants - Philly is locked into the #2 seed in the NFC playoffs and face a Giants team coming off a shocking win last week, but they have just 3 wins all season. Philly could be starting #3 QB Tanner McKee here with Hurts still in protocol and Pickett dealing with an inj too. Philly is making the choice to sit RB Barkley, so he won't have the chance to break the single season rush record. The Giants will go with QB Locke here and he threw for over 300 yards last week. Philly held Dallas to 268 yards last week and forced 4 TO's in a lopsided 41-7 win.
