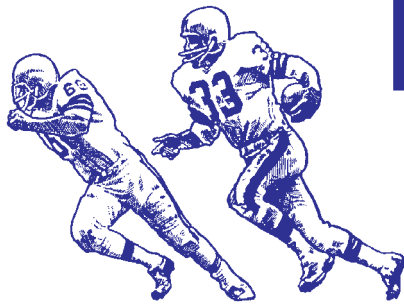

4★ ARMY over Usf - Only 3rd meeting and first as AAC members. They split two meetings in '03-'04. Last week was Brian Hartline's debut as HC at USF. They were outgained by 173 yards vs FIU, finished with just 208 yards but were +3 TO's and won 19-9 (-14). The Bulls faced the option twice last year, allowing 41 pts and 338 rush vs Navy in a 3 pt loss and held Rice to 3 pts and 153 rush in the finale. New DC Josh Aldridge was the DC at East Carolina and they held Army to 6 pts and 290 yds. Army is off a 59-3 win over FCS Bryant. QB Cade Hellums ran for over 1200 yards last year. He returned this year as 1 of 8 starters back on offense for Jeff Monken. The Knights only have 3 starters back on D but USF's offense is brand new and Michael Van Buren threw for just 100 yards LW. The Knights have the coaching edge and experience edge, they are at home and we cashed going against USF for our underdog POW last week so we will do the same for our Top Newsletter Play this week!

FORECAST: Army by 18

3★ AIR FORCE over North Dakota St - North Dakota St is playing its first game as a Mountain West Conference member and making their first trip to Air Force. Bison 5-3 SU & ATS L/8 road openers. Falcons have lost b2b MWC openers SU & ATS. NDST is off to a 2-0 start with wins over Jacksonville St and Fordham by a combined score of 71-7. However, the JaxSt game was only 10-7 right before HT and more competitive than the final score indicates. New QB Nathan Hayes is managing the offense nicely and the D has been lights out. This staff faced The Citadel's triple-option in '25 and won 38-0 while allowing just 110 yds (2.5 ypc). Air Force is 1-0 after handling Duquesne (+28'), 34-0, with a 450-107 yardage edge. The Falcons are looking to rebound from rare b2b losing seasons. The last time that happened, they came back to win 11 in '19. Troy Calhoun's 20th team is built for MWC contention. QB Liam Szarka is healthy again (2 rush td's last week) and a great fit for this offense and the D already looks improved with 8 returning starters. We like the Falcons as a home dog in a low-scoring, grind-it-out game.

FORECAST: AIR FORCE by 10

3★ UTAH over Arkansas - First mtg and first half of home & home with Utah visiting Arkansas in '29. Since '17, Utes 33-20 ATS at home. Since '21, Razorbacks are 4-1 SU & ATS vs Big 12 foes and 5-0 to the over. This is a battle of 1st year HC's. Utah's Morgan Scalleigh, who has been on staff for almost 20 yrs, won his debut over Idaho (+35'), 66-14. QB's Devon Dampier and Byrd Ficklin combined for 5 td's and fueled a 633-225 edge in yds. New Arkansas HC Ryan Silverfield also won his 1st gm over an FCS foe, but only beat N Alabama (+40'), 31-14, while turning the ball over 3 times. He inherits a team that went 2-10 LY but was just -5ypg in SEC play and lost 7 by SD! The Hogs are excited about the backfield of QB KJ Jackson and RB Sutton Smith but they have one of the FBS' least experienced rosters. This looks like a rebuilding year for Arkansas, which has lost 12 straight to P4 opp. While the Hogs are 14-5 ATS as an AD since '20 and have covered 7 straight as a DD dog, that came under the prior staff. Silverfield was 4-6 ATS as an AD at Memphis. Utes roll at night in Salt Lake City.

FORECAST: UTAH by 23

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Alabama over Kentucky - These two last met in '23 in Lexington and Bama won 49-21 (-11) w/a 444-253 yd edge. Crimson Tide were impressive in their opener, putting up a 17-2 FD edge in the first half of a 38-7 (-28) win over East Carolina. It was good to see the maligned Bama Oline step up with a solid performance and with a more athletic QB the run game is more effective. 'Cats opened the Will Stein era w/a 45-13 win over Youngstown St. ND transfer QB Kenny Minchey threw for 301 yds and 4 td's but YSU has a poor FCS D and now he faces a stiffer test against Bama and their outstanding secondary. Bama will continue to run the ball and win their SEC opener by DD's. KY is 12-4 ATS as an SEC HD but that was under Stoops and Bama is on a 9-4 ATS run vs the SEC.

FORECAST: Alabama by 17

2★ Charlotte (+) vs OLE MISS - There may be no bigger sandwich advantage than this game. Ole Miss is off short rest following a 41-38 win over Louisville. The Rebels led 38-24 with under 5 minutes left. They allowed 2 late td's then star K Lucas Carneiro nailed the GW 48 yd fg. Now they get a Charlotte team that just lost to The Citadel last week and the Rebels have the much anticipated return of Lane Kiffin on deck. Ole Miss won't have much reason to run the score up on Charlotte, and the 49ers had a bad matchup last week, facing The Citadel's triple option which put up 268 rush yds. We cashed a 2★ on Charlotte (+43') last year at Georgia and only lost 35-3 and they are getting 47' here. This could be a similar game as Ole Miss can empty the bench and rest the starters to face their former coach next week.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 7 over Rutgers - This is BC's annual Red Bandana Game and it falls on the 25th anniversary of 9/11. BC (-8') lost the last meeting, 22-21, between the 2 schools in '22. Since '11, BC 3-8 is SU & ATS vs B10 opponents (lost at Michigan St last year, 42-40, as a 3-pt dog). Last time here in '22, Rutgers snapped a 14-game winless streak vs BC. The Knights' only lead came on a TD with 2:43 left for the 1-pt upset. In its last 6 vs ACC schools, Rutgers is 5-1 SU & ATS with 4 straight covers. Rutgers QB Dylan Loneragan was the starter at BC last year, but he was hurt last week so Rutgers is going with AJ Surace to make his first start. Last week Rutgers was upset by UMass, 37-21 (-29). BC is led by a D-II transfer QB. Last week Boston College lost to Cincinnati, 34-15 (+7). Tough to go vs. BC on Red Bandana Night, but they are just 5-7 SU in those games.

Missouri by 3 over KANSAS - Missouri leads 58-54-9 in Border War rivalry that began in 1891. Tigers have won 4 straight and 6 of last 7 including last year. Mizzou (-6) was +369 yds but trailed 4Q before scoring final 14 pts in 42-31 win. The dog is 10-6 ATS with 8 outright upsets last 16 games. Tigers opened with a 54-14 win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff (+54'). QB Austin Simmons was sharp in his debut, completing 17-19 for 252 yds and 4 td's as Mizzou was +364 yds. Star RB Ahmad Hardy and AA caliber OT Cayden Green missed the game with injuries. Kansas began '26 with a 51-6 win over LIU (+41'). The game marked the return of OC Andy Kotelnicki with the Jayhawks. His new QB Isaiah Marshall was 14-19 for 246 yds and 2 td's while bruising RB Yasin Willis led with 72 yds and 2 td's. KU HC Leipold is 9-4-1 ATS here as a HD and 19-7-1 during his career. But Mizzou HC Drinkwitz is 7-2 ATS here as an AF. Kansas has not hosted Mizzou since '05 so this will be a big deal in Lawrence. This is a rivalry game so it'll be close. **Normally our Marquess are \$15 but we are giving this one out for free to subscribers! Take Kansas (+5') to cover as our Friday Night Marquee!**

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 12th

Oregon by 27 over OKLAHOMA ST - Oklahoma St (+28) lost last year's first regular season meeting in Eugene, 69-3. Cowboys outgained 631-211 in worst loss of the ex-HC Gundy era. The loss snapped OSU's streak of 8 straight wins/covers in road openers. The Ducks have won both prior meetings ('08 Holiday Bowl & last year in Eugene, 69-3, as 4-TD favorite). In road openers under HC Lanning, Oregon is 4-0 SU & 2-2 ATS. Lanning is 12-6 ATS as an away favorite. They only have Portland St on deck. Last week, Oregon held off Boise St, 34-27 (-25'). Oklahoma St was supposed to be much improved, bringing over all the skill players from last year's potent North Texas offense.

However, last week the Cowboys were upset by in-state rival Tulsa, 24-10 (-13). Oregon is 5-0 ATS as a road non-conf DD favorite, and 10-4 as a DD away favorite.

Oklahoma by 7 over MICHIGAN - Oklahoma makes their first trip to the Big House. Sooners have won their last 4 games vs Big 10 foes. Last year when this game as played OK QB John Materer was healthy. The Sooners had 408-288 yd & 22-12 FD edges. Mich's only td came on a 75 yd td run and the Sooners won 24-13 (-5). Materer is back and Venables boosted his roster with some key transfers, plus they have an experienced OL and the defense is still stout, led by LB Kip Lewis and one of the SEC's top secondaries. The Michigan offense was putrid last week vs Western Michigan. Beyond the obvious controversy from the end of the game, Michigan had just 233 yards until the Hail Mary pass that won the game. Whittingham was only 4-4 as a home dog the last 10 years at Utah. OK won all 4 road games last year including at Bama and Tenn. Whittingham said Underwood is the starting QB "for now" and we don't expect him to fair any better against the Sooners D. OK wins by a td in a low scoring game.

Wake Forest by 7 over PURDUE - Purdue leads series 4-1, but the teams last met in '03. Its their first game vs ACC since '23 (beat VT/lost Syr). The last 4 years, the Boilermakers are just 5-19 ATS at home (2-10 as home dog). It's Wake's first regular season game vs. a Big Ten opponent since '16 (Deacons 1-2 in bowls in '19, '20, '21). WF is 9-1 SU in road openers since '16 (7-3 ATS). Wake had a great first year for HC Dickert last season, going 9-4. Last week, Wake Forest defeated visiting Akron, 38-16 (-27'). Purdue was just 2-10 in Barry Odom's first year, but do have a solid QB in Ryan Browne and, unlike last year, did not bring in 30+ transfers after spring practice, so they are more of a team this year. Last week Purdue defeated FCS in-state rival Indiana St, 44-19 (-35'). Odom is 1-5 ATS as a home dog here and Dickert is 6-4 ATS as an away favorite. Demon Deacons lead a road win to move to 2-0.

VIRGINIA TECH by 28 over Old Dominion - ODU has beaten Virginia Tech 3 times in 7 mtgs (4-3 ATS) including LY. Hokies were embarrassed at home, allowing the 1st 31pts and 526 yds in 45-26 loss. HC Brent Pry was fired the next day so this is a revenge spot for VT. The HC's, ODU's Ricky Rahne & VT's James Franklin, were on the Penn St staff from '14-'19. Monarchs are 1-0 after beating Norfolk St, 31-10, as a 40-pt favorite. The bar is high after the team went 10-3 in '25. The offense has taken a step back with a new QB and just 1 returning starter (just 16 fd's and 319 yds last week) but the D has 6 starters back and Rahne is 11-4 ATS since '22 as a DD dog and 16-9 ATS here as an AD. The Franklin era in Blacksburg began with a 73-3 over VMI (+55'). Franklin kept Fry on as his DC which was a great offseason move. After hitting rock bottom LY at 3-9, this will be a much improved VT team that will play with something to prove vs ODU. Before going winless in '25, Franklin was 23-10-2 ATS as a DD fav in his previous 5 years at Penn St. The Hokies get revenge for Pry and move to 2-0 with a win by 4 td's.

PENN ST by 28 over Temple - Penn St leads series 40-4-1. Last time here in '15, Lions (-6') lost, 27-10, to snap a 38-0-1 streak vs the Owls (previous loss in 1941!). Since '22, PSU 11-4 ATS as road fav and they will have the crowd edge in this one as the schools are just 114 miles apart. First meeting since '16 (Temple lost, 34-27, as 7-pt dog and has covered L/2 vs PSU). Last 7 vs Big Ten, Owls 3-4 SU & 5-2 ATS. Last year, Temple took on two P4 teams and lost by an avg of 30 ppg. They are improved but are breaking in a new QB. Last week Temple defeated Rhode Island of the FCS, 38-14 (-14'). Matt Campbell brought 24 players with him from Iowa St. Campbell is 17-20-1 as an AF. Penn St hasn't been a DD non-conf away favorite since 2008! Last week, Penn St made Campbell's debut memorable, blowing out Marshall 45-0 (-23'). Penn St only has Buffalo on deck.

TEXAS A&M by 24 over Arizona St - Texas A&M won the only prior meeting in '15, 38-17. That game was played in Houston and the Devils are making their first trip to College Station. Both teams had lopsided wins last week. A&M has 18 returning starters from a playoff team. Marcel Reed is back and they have their top rusher and two of their top 3 receivers back. ASU is 1-7 SU/3-5 ATS vs the SEC. Kenny Dillingham's squad went from 11 wins in '24 to 8 wins in '25. Cutter Boley transferred in from Kentucky and threw for 387 yards and 6 td's in his debut vs Morgan St. Elko is only 5-11 ATS at home while Dillingham was 10-5 ATS on the road. While the angles say take ASU, A&M has a big talent edge and won't look ahead to next week's SEC opener vs Kentucky. Aggies have the edge in all 3 phases and win by 3 td's.

KANSAS ST by 13 over Washington St - First meeting and first half of home & home, with KSU visiting Wazzu in '29. This is a battle of first-year coaches. The Collin Klein era in Manhattan began with a 71-3 win over Nicholls (+41'). The offense was balanced and explosive and the defense allowed just 9 fd's and 122 yds. The Wildcats have a lot of question marks and they lost 2 key OL to injuries in the summer. However, Klein is a former QB & OC here, and QB Avery Johnson really began to emerge under his tutelage in '23 so the offense shows potential in '26. First year HC Kirby Moore lost the Apple Cup opener to Washington, 24-10, but the Cougars were within 7 late in the 4Q and kept the Husky offense from taking off. Moore was the Missouri OC and made a nice pickup in UC Davis QB Caden Pinnick. They also have talent at the skill positions. But this is Wazzu's 3rd HC in 3 years and Moore & Co. have a lot of holes to fill. This program did well to have b2b winning seasons but will struggle getting back there in '26. Wazzu is scrappy and even off a short week and a rivalry game, they'll keep this game within 2 td's.

GEORGIA by 42 over Wku - Georgia won the only prior meeting 48-12 in 2006. Georgia was 0-15-1 ATS under Kirby Smart when favored by 38 pts or more until LW when they beat Tennessee St 63-3 (-47'). WKU is 1-3 ATS as a road non-conf dog of 20+ pts. Georgia has their SEC opener at Arkansas on deck. LW WKU was crushed 49-14 at Nevada. Things don't get any easier for WKU next week when they play the defending Nat'l Champs in Bloomington. Georgia will play their back-ups most of the 2nd half and their history of taking it easy in these games gives us pause but Helton will be happy to get his team out of Athens healthy.

WASHINGTON by 24 over Utah St - Utah St lost the last meeting, 31-17, in '15 as 7-pt dog. Last 10 road openers, Aggies 2-8 SU/5-5 ATS. Utah St 1-8 vs B10 but covered 2 of last 3 in '18 & '23 (one SU win over Wisc in 1968). Huskies have won all 3 meetings (1904, '98, '15) & covered last 2. Since '13, UW 9-1 SU & 7-3 ATS vs MWC (Utah St's conference from 2013-25). Since '19, Huskies 10-3-1 ATS as DD favorite in non-conf regular season games. The Huskies are 8-3 ATS at as a heavy favorite under HC Fisch, 6-3 ATS as a non-conf heavy favorite by 20+. Last week, Washington beat Washington St, 24-10, to win the Apple Cup (-24). They only have Eastern Washington on deck. Utah St is a lot more veteran team than last year with 3 starters back on the O-line. New QB Micah Hillstead started 4 games here in '23 transferred to BYU and is back. Last week, Utah St was upset by FCS Idaho St, 29-17 (-15')! Mendenhall is 35-24-1 ATS as an away dog. Mendenhall is 7-0 ATS as a dog of 20+ pts!

BYU by 17 over Arizona - Last 5 meetings, BYU is 5-0 SU & 4-1 ATS. LTH in '24, Arizona (+2') was only -9 yds but threw 3 int's in a 41-19 loss. Cats are 1-5 SU L/6 road openers and 0-2 SU & ATS under HC Brent Brennan. BYU won LY's meeting in Tucson, 33-27, in 2 OT as a 2-pt favorite. Cougars trailed late but rallied for 10pts in final 4:08. In the opener, Arizona defeated Northern Arizona (+31'), 35-7, and was +327 yds but -2 TO's or else the gap would have been bigger. Brennan has done a great job building Arizona back and returns All-Big 12 QB Noah Fifita to run the offense. The Big 12 title could go through Provo this season. The Cougars won 23 combined games in '23 & '24 and this could be HC Kalani Sitake's best team in his 11 seasons. Last week, they beat Utah Tech, 63-7, as a 51-pt favorite. In QB Bear Bachmeier and RB LJ Martin, BYU has one of the FBS' top backfields and the veteran D returns 8 starters. The Cougars are legit playoff contenders and Sitake is 10-3 ATS at home the last 2 years. They're better than Arizona at nearly every position and will roll at home by more than 2 td's.

PITTSBURGH by 10 over Ucf - These two split two meetings in '18 & '19, the home team won & covered both. Last week UCF led 73-0 when Bethune Cookman scored their only td on the final play of the game. Pitt had no problems with Miami, OH last week in a 59-14 (-16") win. QB Heinschel threw for 453 yds and 7 td's. The Panthers have edge in the trenches, returning 3 starters on the Dline that allowed 95 (2.7) ypg last year and the Oline has 4 starters back. UCF has 10 starters back from last year's team and added 3 transfer starters including QB Alonza Barnett who led JMU to the playoffs last year. Frost is 13-10 as an away dog but they were 1-4 in that role last year. Narduzzi is 23-25-3 as a HF but they went 4-0 last year. Also the Over in Pitt home non-conf games is 15-2! We give Pitt a 10 pt edge at home.

Maryland by 17 over UCONN - Maryland leads the series, 3-1. Last meeting in '24, UConn (+19) allowed a season-high 629 yards in a 50-7 road loss. After beating Indiana in '03 & '06, Huskies have lost 7 straight to Big Ten schools (2-5 ATS). Last time here in '13, Maryland (-6) racked up 501 yds in 32-21 win. Terps have won 5 straight road openers (4-1 ATS). Maryland is in Year 8 for HC Mike Locksley and he has won 15 straight non conference games. He is also 14-7 ATS vs non-conf teams. The Terrapins are 2-0 as an away non-conf favorite. UConn has a new HC in Jason Candle and he has a brand new team, after Jim Mora took quite a few transfers with him to Colorado St. Last week, Maryland blew out FCS Hampton, 62-0 (-45). Last week, UConn dominated FCS Lafayette, 56-7 (-21).

ILLINOIS by 7 over Duke - The Blue Devils (+2) lost last year at home in the schools' first meeting since 1965, 45-19. Duke outgained Illinois 438-419 & trailed by 1 at half, but were -5 TO's and it was 31-6 in the second half. In their last 12 vs B10 schools, Duke is 8-4 SU & 9-3 ATS. After 3 straight losses, Illinois has won/covered last 2 vs ACC. Under HC Bret Bielema, Illinois is 10-11-2 as a home favorite (but 4-0-1 last year). The Illini figure to take a step back from last year's team. They are 13-2 SU at home the last 3 years. New QB Katin Houser was a two-year starter at East Carolina. Last week, Illinois defeated UAB, 42-23 (-25). Duke dominated the line of scrimmage in the 1st half vs Illinois last year, but they did lose QB Mensah to Miami (FL) and their new QB is San Jose St transfer Walker Eget. Last week Duke defeated Tulane, 17-3 (-9.5). Nate Shepard is back at RB. Manny Diaz is 10-4 ATS as an away dog and Bielema is 10-11-2 ATS as a home favorite.

UAB by 3 over ULM - Back half of home & home. In '24, UAB (-11) lost at ULM 32-6. Blazers allowed just 296 yds but were -3 TO's and gave up pick6 and safety. UAB opened the Alex Mortensen era with a 42-23 loss at Illinois (-27'). Blazers actually had 413-332 yardage edge but allowed 3 td's of 50+ yards including a pick 6 and a Hail Mary before HT. The D is being rebuilt but Mortensen has done a nice job with the offense and QB Ryder Burton has a chance to play in the NFL. This is a pivotal Year 3 for ULM HC Bryant Vincent who entered '26 just 8-16 after going 3-9 LY. His best team in Monroe opened with a 62-13 loss at Mississippi St (-28'), allowing the Bulldogs a school-record 762 yds. The Warhawks have veteran QB Aidan Armenta and addressed special teams issues that cost them games in '25. On the road, ULM is 4-40 SU & 16-28 ATS since '19. UAB is 22-10-2 ATS as a home favorite since '17. They held their own vs Illinois and will keep ULM reeling away from home. However, Vincent was at UAB from '18-'22 (interim HC in '22) and has a track record of success in September vs non-SEC schools, so it'll be very close.

MINNESOTA by 7 over Mississippi St - First meeting between the two schools. The Gophers are 3-1 SU & ATS in their last 4 vs SEC schools (all bowl games). Minnesota's last regular season game vs SEC was in 1959 (beat Vandy, 20-6)! It's Mississippi St's 1st regular season game vs the Big Ten since 1980. MSU 2-3 ATS & SU L/5 road openers. It is also 6-3 as an away dog. This is Year 3 for HC Jeff Leiby. Last week Mississippi St defeated ULM, 62-13 (28'). They do have their SEC opener on deck. Minnesota has a veteran QB in Chip Lindsay, an improved run game and is 21-8 SU at home the last 5 years, including 7-0 last year. Last week, the Gophers blew out FCS Eastern Illinois, 59-7 (-42'). It is a rare trip North for Miss St and the Gophers only have Akron on deck.

Unlv by 7 over NORTH TEXAS - North Texas is 0-5 in the regular season vs UNLV and on a 1-3 slide in home openers. In last mgt in '22, Rebels had 576 yards in 58-27 win. Mean Green starting a new era under former Troy & WVU HC Neal Brown. They lost his debut last wk at Indiana, 52-16, as a 40th pt dog. However, they only trailed by 15 at the start of the 4Q and were +2 yds! UNT went 12-2 LY but their HC and many of their top players are now at OkSt and zero starters are back. This is a work in progress but Brown is a veteran with a track record. UNLV is 1-1 in HC Dan Mullen's 2nd season, losing the opener to Memphis before keeping Hawaii out of the end zone in Saturday's 21-6 road win. They have a bye next week. The offense is ahead of the D, with QB Jackson Arnold and RB Jet Thomas in the backfield and the receiving corps improved. Mullen is 6-0 ATS as an AF since getting to Vegas in '25 and the program is 11-2 as an AF since '23. This is a tough turnaround trip going to Texas a week after traveling to Hawaii, but the Rebels have covered 17 straight road non-conference games and have momentum after last week!

VANDERBILT by 14 over Delaware - First mtg. Vandy has covered their last 11 vs CUSA foes going back to 2008 but they were only a DD fav in 2 of those. 'Dores opened LW vs FCS Austin Peay. It was only 15-9 at half and they won 28-9 (-29). QB's Berlowitz and true frosh phenom Jared Curtis combined for 18-205 and 209 yds but no td's. Delaware is the most experienced team in CUSA (#17 in FBS) and largely a hometown team as HC Ryan Carty retained much of the roster. Blue Hens QB Nick Minicucci threw for over 3600 yds w/ a 23-7 ratio LY and 330 vs Merrimack in a 42-7 win LW. The Blue Hens upset UConn LY and that Huskies team won 9 games. Vandy is #27 in experience but still adjusting to life after Pavia so we like the dog to cover. Vandy is 3-10 ATS as a home non-conf fav of 21 pts or more.

BOISE ST by 14 over Memphis - Second meeting between 2 of the top G6 teams. The Broncos (-3) lost, 35-32, in Memphis in '23 despite having a 519-448 yard edge. Boise has lost last 3 to American, including 34-7 last year to USF (+5'). The Broncos have covered 5 of their L/6 home openers. Memphis 2-0 vs MWC (Boise's old conference) and 2-1 vs Pac-12 (Boise's new league). Memphis is 57-12 SU at home the last 11 years but just 27-24 on the road. Boise is 52-11 SU at home. They are 11-3-1 as a heavy favorite. Memphis lost their HC - new HC Huff is 8-5 as an away dog. Boise has QB Maddux Madsen back after he missed games last year. HC Danielson is 4-1 ATS as a non conf home favorite. Last week, Boise St lost to Oregon, 34-27 (+25'), while Memphis defeated Arkansas St, 42-24 (-10'). Boise is 14-4-1 ATS as a home favorite the last 4 years and Memphis is 5-10-1 ATS as an away dog the last 11 years.

FIU by 21 over Buffalo First meeting. While Buffalo is just 1-6 SU playing in the state of Florida, they won their last trip here in 2015 beating FAU 33-15 as a 2 pt AD. Bulls are just 1-6 SU & 3-ATS in road openers they did cover LY at Minnesota only losing 23-10 (+17). FIU has won 5 straight home openers (3-2 ATS) and are 3-0 ATS vs MAC teams including upsetting Central Michigan. 52-16 (+5) in '24. Lu Buffalo (-17) barley got by FCS Albany trailing 17-14 late 3Q before scoring a GW td with 4:53 left. UB then needed a SOD at their own 3 with 1:02 left to preserve the win. FIU lost their opener to USF 19-9 but covered as a 14' pt AD only trailing 6-3 into 4Q, finishing with a 381-208 yd edge but were -3 TO's. FIU is clearly the better team and as just a 10' pt HF. We will take FIU here and you may want to take them early in the week as this line could climb.

OHIO by 3 over Jacksonville St - Only prior meeting was in the '24 Cure Bowl, Ohio (-6) led 27-7 2Q & 30-14 4Q but needed to run out final 3:35 to hold on for a 30-27 win. Bobcats are 4-0 SU & 3-1 ATS including beating West Virginia outright 17-10 as a 3* pt HD. Jax St is just 5-11 ATS as an AD including a 33-7 loss at NDSU (+7*) in their opener. LNW they covered (-20*) at home vs FCS ECU 49-7. LWO Ohio (+24) put a scare into Nebraska leading 13-7 2Q & only trailing 28-21 4Q before allowing final 21 including a 3 play 17 yd td drive with just 1:53 left. Ohio is an amazing 23-1 SU at home s/22 but 17-7 ATS and while we expect Ohio to win Jax St should keep it close.

TULANE by 14 over South Alabama - Last 3 mtgs, Tulane 3-0 SU but 1-2 ATS. Green Wave won LY, 33-31, but allowed 421 yds and 2 td's in final 5:27 to lose ATS. USA 0-7 SU & 3-4 ATS vs American foes. After winning 43 games from '22-'25, keeping Tulane on the tracks now belongs to HC Will Hall who went 14-30 in 4 ssns at Southern Miss. The roster has been overhauled but Hall has done a good job of rebuilding through the portal. This is his home opener after the Green Wave (+7) fell to Duke. The D allowed 250 rush yds and the offense had just 10 fd's. It was a tough spot against a highly motivated Blue Devil squad. Tulane has lost 5 straight ATS as a DD fav. USA began Year 3 under HC Major Applewhite by allowing 231 yds in a 39-14 win over Southeastern Louisiana (+12). Jags lack the NIL budget of Tulane and it'll show in the personnel gap. All things considered, Applewhite is doing a solid and he has a veteran QB in Bishop Davenport. However, it won't be enough against the skill position speed of the Green Wave. Power Plays has Tulane 35-16 and we agree that they'll look much stronger in Week 2.

Tulsa by 14 over SAM HOUSTON - Tulsa won only prior mtg in '09 56-3 when SH was an FCS team. LY Tulsa was -3' at CUSA's NMST and lost 21-14. We cashed a 3★ Newsletter play and LPS in Tulsa's outright upset win over OKSt LW. The Golden Hurricane were +14 yet never trailed and won 24-10. LY Tulsa upset OKSt then lost to Tulane the following week 31-14 (+15) at home. SH QB Landyn Locke threw for 335 yards and 3 td's as SH nearly upset Troy as 16' pt dogs, losing 24-21. SH actually gets to play real home games this year after having to travel at Shell Energy Stadium in Houston, over an hour drive away from campus. Our expectations were higher for Tulsa coming in, but Sam Houston was better than expected LW and Tulsa just had an emotional win so we are cutting our line off at 2 td's.

Appalachian St (+) over EAST CAROLINA - App St has won 3 in a row SU & ATS in '21, '23 and '24, and the favorite has covered 4 straight in the series. East Carolina began Year 3 under HC Harrell with a 48-10 loss at Alabama (-28). The Pirates were outgained 487-162 and had just 5 fd's and 2 yds rushing. They won 8 in '24 and 9 in '25 but return just 3 starters from last year's squad. Harrell is doing a good job mining the portal so they'll improve as the season unfolds and the new players build chemistry. After going 5-8 in '25, App St begins Year 2 under HC Loggains. They opened by wallowing Maine, 55-3 (-18) with a 397 yd edge which won us a 3★ FCS LPS Play. The Mountaineers are also rebuilding but figure to be better this season, especially at QB with Purdue transfer Malachi Singleton who debuted by hitting 22-24 for 291 yds and 3 td's. They also added RB Ja'Quez Cross who rushed for 66 yds on just 7 carries. This will be a tough instate battle and we think App State is under the radar so we will call for the outright upset!

NEBRASKA by 28 over Bowling Green - First meeting. Nebraska is 8-1 SU vs MAC teams (lost in '17 to then MAC foe NIU) and are 6-3 ATS including 5 straight covers. Last week the Cornhuskers faced another MAC foe. Nebraska (-24) struggled with Ohio 13-7 2Q and only led 28-21 in the 4Q. Then up just 42-21 got the break of the game returning an int to the Ohio 17 and 3 plays later got the front door cover td with just 1:53 left. While Bowling Green is off a loss 20-13 loss to an FCS team they were only favored by 3 as Tarleton St is a top 10 FCS foe. Tarleton St also had 10 pts off 2 BG fumbles in their own territory Nebraska only has an FCS foe on deck and with last weeks scare will not look past another MAC team. The Falcons however are 6-0 ATS the last 3 years vs P4 teams, so they are still capable of keeping it around the spread which is bigger than normal because of Bowling Green's loss last week.

Tennessee by 6 over GEORGIA TECH - These two last met in '17's opener when UT won 42-41 in 2OT. Vols true frosh QB Faizon Brandon had 5 td's vs Furman in LW's 56-9 win. GTEch is trying to avoid their first 0-2 start since 1983. Jackets struggles in trenches were jarring in the loss to Colorado. They were outtrashed 183-51 with neither of their lines getting any push. Now they face a Tennessee offense that returns 1000 yd rusher DeSean Bishop and 4 starting OL. Jim Knowles D had 6 sacks in the opener including 3 from Penn St transfer Xavier Gilliam. However, Brent Key is 11-4 ATS vs ranked teams with 7 outright upsets and Jackets are 8-0 ATS as single-digit dogs. This is Faizon Brandon's first road start and GT's pass D only allowed 52% and 124 yds LW. Vols run game will do enough to win the game but GT keeps it close.

MARSHALL by 17 over Middle Tennessee - Former CUSA foes meet for 2nd straight year. Marshall (-3) won LY on the road, 42-28, rallying by scoring the final 21pts. LTH in '20, MTSU (+24) lost 42-14. Blue Raiders are 1-7 ATS last 8 road openers. MTSU began Year 3 under Derek Mason by beating Murray St (+20), 38-14. They were only +106 yds vs a bad Racers squad and weather cancelled the game with 11:11 left when Murray St was knocking on the door. Mason has won just 3 games in each of his 1st 2 seasons and he's 8-16 as a DD dog. He does have his best offense, led by QB Roman Gagliano and a talented backfield. Marshall is looking for its 1st win after losing at Penn St (-23) last week, 45-0. They had just 147 yds and never cracked the red zone, so they'll be looking to bust out this weekend and have the playmakers to do it. The Herd went 5-7 in HC Tony Gibson's debut and were 0-2 ATS as a HF. Gibson retained QB Carlos Del Rio-Wilson and added DC Brad Lambert, and they'll be a contender in the Sun Belt East. They'll play like it at home and even their mark with a 17-point win.

KENNESAW ST by 14 over Georgia St - Schools are only 24 miles apart. GAST won only prior meeting in '18 24-20. KSU upset a Sun Belt foe LY in Ark St 28-21 (+4). Owls went on to win CUSA in Jerry Mack's first year. They have 9 returning starters including 8 from last year. LW they crushed a rebuilding West Georgia team 47-0 (-23). GAST is off a 1-11 season though they were only -29 ypg in SBC play. Panthers have 8 starters back, all from LY's team and QB Cameran Brown had a 13-1 ratio LY. LW they beat NC A&T 59-10. GAST is 6-18-1 ATS under 3rd year HC Dell McGee while KSU is 11-4 ATS under Jerry Mack. KSU has won 8 straight at home (7-1 ATS) and GSU has lost 14 of their last 15 on the road (4-10-1 ATS).

UCLA by 10 over San Diego St - It's the Pac-12's newest school vs a longtime former member. Aztecs' only series win came the last time here in '19. SDSU (+8) was +112 yds & won 23-14 - their first game vs a B10 school since '15 (13 straight SU losses & 4 straight ATS losses). Bruins lead the series 22-1-1 (lost at home, 23-14, in '19). UCLA (-14) won the last meeting in '23, 35-10, out-gaining Aztecs 550-259. Bruins 0-4 ATS vs the MWC (SDSU's former conference). UCLA has a new HC in Bob Chesney and he brings over some key players from James Madison, which he took to the playoffs last year. Last week UCLA beat old Pac-12 rival Cal, 45-24 (-2) on the road, and they have Purdue on deck. San Diego St had a dominant defense last year but lost a lot of it. They were average on offense with a banged up QB Jayden Denegal, but he is now 100%, so that unit will be more of a force. Last week, San Diego St defeated FCS Portland St, 53-20 (-38). UCLA is 8-19-1 ATS as a home favorite the last 8 years, but SDSU HC Sean Lewis is 12-18 ATS as an away dog.

CLEMSON by 24 over Georgia Southern - Clemson won only mtg in '18, 38-7, as 32pt favorite. Under HC Helton, Georgia Southern is 3-1 ATS when getting 20+ points. Normally, this would be a sandwich spot for the Tigers who suffered the worst loss of the Dabo Swinney era last week at LSU, 51-10, and have the ACC opener next week with Carolina. But after LSU, there's no chance of a lookahead. They were embarrassed in Baton Rouge and outgained 644-145! Clemson is breaking in a new QB and even after the opener should be improved after going 7-6 for their first worst season since '10. Since '21, Tigers just 12-21 ATS as a DD fav. Georgia Southern opened the season by beating Charleston Southern (+25) 31-0 while allowing just 5 fd's and 35 total yds. The Eagles are led by QB Max Johnson who has ACC & SEC experience. The defense returns 7 of the top 13 tacklers and the front 7 could be Helton's best since he's been here. GS has lost 3 straight ATS when getting 20+ points from P4 opponents. This could be shades of '24 when Clemson lost the opener to Georgia by 31 and then hammered AppSt 66-20 the next Saturday.

Navy by 6 over FAU - Navy has won 3 straight vs FAU but the Owls are 2-1 ATS. LY Owls were +14 at Navy. FAU trailed 21-13 at half, lost 42-32. LW Navy beat Towson 42-15. We went with the Over (59) for our 4★ LP Top Totals play LW and our customers got an easy winner as the game cashed mid 3Q and FAU allowed 66 points by themselves in a 45 point loss. The Owls allowed 624 yards including 281 on the ground. Now they face a Navy rush attack that put up 292 ypg (5.8) LY. FAU QB Caden Veltkamp threw for 276 in the loss LW and should have a better day against a Navy secondary that was #120 in our pass D rankings in '25. We have Navy by a fg and the Over will be in the mix again for our Totals GOM!

IOWA by 27 over Iowa St - This is the 73rd meeting for Cy-Hawk Trophy. After winning 6 straight from '15-'21, Iowa has lost the last 2 & 3 of last 4. The Hawkeyes have lost last 2 at home (HT 1-4

SU & 0-5 ATS L/5). Iowa is 6-3 ATS in this series. The visitor is 18-9 ATS with 5 straight wins in this series. Last time here in '24, ISU (+2) rallied from down 13-0 to win on 54-yd FG with 6 seconds left. Last year, Iowa St again won on a 54-yard FG at the end. Iowa doesn't have a lot of experience, but have a very stable team under HC Kirk Ferentz and will be solid as usual. Iowa St lost HC Campbell and he took 20+ players with him to Penn St so Iowa St is a shadow of last year's team. Last week, Iowa shut out Northern Illinois, 40-0 (-31), while Iowa St defeated FCS Southeast Missouri St, 38-10 (-29). The last 8 meetings have all been decided by 10 or less, BUT in Matt Campbell's first year at Iowa St, Ferentz won, 42-3. He finally faces a 1st year Iowa St HC again this year.

AUBURN by 28 over Southern Miss - Auburn is 0-2 ATS in 2 recent meetings with the Tigers winning by 11 & 14 back in '18 & '08. LW Auburn pulled their game out vs Baylor by just inches, stopping Baylor's GW 2-pt attempt. SMiss was impressive in Blake Anderson's HC debut, beating Alcorn St (-18) 49-3 with a 543-223 yd edge. This is a huge sandwich game for Auburn with Florida on deck. Alex Golesh was 7-5-1 ATS as a home favorite during his time at USF. SMiss is on an 0-6 ATS skid vs the SEC.

LSU by 35 over Louisiana Tech - These two met just last year and LSU only won 23-7 (-37). This is a huge sandwich game with LSU coming off a dominant 51-10 win over Clemson and the Lane Kiffin Bowl next week at Ole Miss. LSU wasn't the only team to blow away their competition as LA Tech put up a school record 80 points against Northwestern St. Kiffin was 7-4 ATS at Ole Miss when laying over 30 points. LA Tech is 6-0 ATS when a dog of 30+ points. It's scary to go against LSU but with so much talk about Kiffin going back to Oxford next week we can easily see them pulling back.

TEXAS by 4 over Ohio St - Ohio St has covered the last 4 vs Texas. LY was Julian Sayin's first start. The Buckeyes held Texas to 203 yards and won 14-7 and we cashed a 3★ LP Totals Play on the Under 47. These offenses are much better this year with Sayin and Arch Manning having experience and a bevy of weapons around them. Texas beat Texas St 59-7 though they did give up 349 yards including 225 in the first half. OSU is off a 56-3 win over Ball St where they had a 671-165 yd edge. OSU is 7-2 ATS as an away dog since 2009 while Sark is 10-5 ATS as a HF here. The difference here is Texas' D, led by DE Collin Simmons while OSU lost 8 draft picks from their defense. We will go with the home team in a close game that will be higher scoring than last year's defensive struggle.

Texas Tech by 28 over OREGON ST - Texas Tech making first trip to Corvallis. Red Raiders won LY at home, 45-14, as 24pt favorite but are 1-6 SU & ATS in L/7 road openers (won at Utah LY). Oregon St snapped an 0-4 ATS slide with LY's 27-24 loss to Houston (-13). TT kicked off the '26 season with a 33-10 win over Abilene Christian (+42). In his return from last year's injury, QB Will Hammond shook off some rust to go 26-33 for 298 yds, 1 td and 1 int. Red Raiders looking to build off LY's 12-2, Big 12 title season. They remain the class of the conf but QB play will be under the microscope all year. TT went 9-1 ATS as a DD fav in '25 and 3-1 ATS as an AF. This is OSU's 2nd straight game vs the Big 12. Beavers' lost new HC Jamaricus Shepard's debut to Houston last week, 33-20, as a 20pt dog. They got 376 pass yds from Mercer transfer QB Braden Atkinson and kept things close despite yielding 533 yds. OSU has won just 3 of their last 19 games, averaged only 18ppg LY and still have a long way to go with a new staff. They'll be improved but not this early and not against a TT team with far superior talent on both sides of the ball.

FRESNO ST by 28 over Sacramento St - Fresno St has won all 9 mtgs including 46-30 in '24 as a 17pt favorite. Sacramento St earned the backdoor cover late in 4Q of loss. Bulldogs started Year 2 under Matt Entz with a 39-0 loss at USC (outgained 552-116). They're coming off an impressive 9-4 season and won LY's home opener over Georgia Southern, 42-14, as a 1pt dog. Despite the opener at the Coliseum, Fresno St looks stronger on both sides of the ball, has experience and the benefit of a 2nd year staff. They're contenders in the newly configured Pac-12. Sac St's 1st season as an FBS member began with a 28-17 loss at Eastern Michigan (outgained 260-34 in 1H) and last week's 52-0 win over Mississippi Valley St, one of the weakest FCS teams. Entering this season, the Hornets were 9-1-1 ATS in their L/11 vs FBS opponents. They're being led by 1st year HC Alonzo Carter who didn't learn that his team was moving to the FBS until after Signing Day and after the portal window closed. We see a mismatch here, with Fresno St poised to do to SacSt what USC did to them on the opening weekend.

USC by 31 over Louisiana - This is the first meeting between the two schools. At 1,763 miles, this is Cajuns' longest road trip of the year. Louisiana is 0-5 all-time vs B10 schools (2-3 ATS), with last meeting a 35-24 loss at Minnesota in '23. Last 4 years, the Cajuns are 4-4 ATS as double-digit dog. The Trojans are 3-0 SU & ATS vs SBC, winning by avg of 58-12 (beat Ga Southern, 59-20, last year as 29-pt favorite). Under HC Lincoln Riley, USC 11-5-1 ATS vs non-conf & 13-11 ATS as double-digit favorite. Last week, USC blanked Fresno St, 39-0 (-21). Louisiana has faced 3 ranked P4 teams the last 5 years and lost those by an average of 31 ppg. Last week, the Ragin Cajuns defeated FCS Lamar, 38-7 (-20). USC is a playoff contender and this is already Game 3 for them.

HAWAII by 11 over New Mexico St - These schools were WAC foes from '05-'11 until Hawaii left for the MWC. Warriors lead series 11-1 but is 1-3-1 ATS last 5 meetings. LTH in '23, New Mexico St (+3) blew 17-3 lead and lost 20-17. After winning 4 straight ATS vs MWC, Aggies have lost last 4 meetings. Both teams have played twice already. Hawaii blew a late lead at Stanford in the opener before last week's disappointing 21-6 home loss to UNLV (0-2 SU & ATS). Under HC Chang, Warriors are 7-2-1 ATS as a home favorite and QB Micah Alejado will look to rebound after throwing for just 176 yds and 0 td's. HC Tony Sanchez's 3rd NMST team is his deepest one, and it has shown so far. The Aggies (+30) only lost by 17 at Florida St in the opener before beating Mercyhurst (+28) in last week's home opener, 51-14 (2-0 ATS). Sanchez has his best QB, big-armed Furman transfer Trey Hedden, and OL rooms in 3 years and the D returns 4 of last year's top 6 tacklers. This is a competitive team with a chance to make a run at a bowl game. However, Hawaii will play with a sense of urgency and capture their 1st win of the season.
