## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ MARYLAND over Michigan St** - Maryland joined the Big 10 in '14 and since then Michigan St leads the series 6-3 SU but 4-5 ATS. All 9 games have gone Under with an AVG 39 ppg. Last year Maryland (-7) took a 21-0 lead and never looked back in a 31-9 win, Michigan St settled for 2 FGs, were stopped on downs at the 1 yard line and were -4 TOs. Last time here in '22 Michigan St (+7) was down just 21-13 at half but got shutout in the 2H and gave up 489 yards losing 27-13. Those two wins mark the first time Maryland has won two straight in the series. We went against Sparty last week and cashed our Friday Night Marquee in their 16-10 (-13) win over FAU. MSU only put up 293 yards and new starting QB Aidan Chiles was just 10 of 24 passing for 114 yards and threw 2 int's. Maryland (-19) put up 629 yards of offense vs UConn, winning 50-7. Maryland has a stout Dline that we expect them to shut down a struggling Michigan St offense. With the line just over a td we will go with the Terps for our top Newsletter Play. Crabcakes and Football, That's what Maryland does!

**FORECAST: MARYLAND by 23 over Michigan St**

**3★ OHIO over South Alabama** - First meeting. Ohio is off a 38-22 loss to 'Cuse (3★ LP play on Over 44!) where RB Tyus exploded for 203 yards (12.7) and 2 td's. SAla is off a 52-38 loss to NTexas where we cashed the Underdog POW outright winner on the Mean Green! SAla gave up 550 yards last week and Ohio QB Navarro could be in for a big day passing. As of presstime Ohio is a slight dog and the 'Cats are 4-0 ATS since '22 as a home dog with all four covers also being outright upsets. We'll also give the coaching edge to Ohio and Tim Albin. While both teams lost last week, Ohio impressed up haging around with a good ACC squad, while the Jags showed their inexperience vs NTex especially on defense. Peden Stadium will be packed for the 'Cats opener and we'll side with the Green and White to win over by a td.

**FORECAST: OHIO by 10**

**3★ Georgia Southern over WASHINGTON ST** - First game as FBS foes. Georgia Southern is off a 56-45 loss (3★ newsletter winner on GS + the points) vs Boise while Nev went to Troy trailed 14-6 HT and comeback 2H to win 28-26. Georgia Southern is led by QB French (322 yds LW) and the Eagles have a talented WR room going up against an average secondary & their defense is facing a much easier task this week. Georgia Southern led the best team in the MW 37-36 last week and put up 461 yards on Boise's defense. Now they face one of the worst MW teams in Nevada who gave up nearly 400 yards to an inexperienced Troy team last week. Georgia Southern is a better Sun Belt team than Nevada just played and it took a 2H comeback for the 'Pack to squeak out a win. We'll take the high-flying Eagles offense to go to Reno and get the DD victory. **FORECAST: Georgia Southern by 11**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Eastern Michigan (+) over WASHINGTON** - First meeting. Eastern Michigan has played a P4 opponent the last two years, last year vs Minnesota were only down 10-6 at half but were shutout in the 2H losing 25-6 but covered as 20 pt dogs. In '22 vs Arizona St (+20) they upset the Sun Devils 30-21 thanks to a 458-352 yard edge. Washington last played a MAC opponent back in '22 as 23 point favorite over Kent St winning 45-20. EMich is on an astonishing 29-9 ATS run as away dogs and just last week upset UMass 28-14 (+2) on the road. Washington has the Apple Cup on deck so with the VegasLine being right around 4 TDs we won't hesitate to take Eagles to keep it closer than expected.

**FORECAST: Washington by 18**

**2★ Texas over MICHIGAN** - These two power house programs meet for the first time since the '05 Rose Bowl won by Texas 38-37 and this is their first regular season meeting ever! Texas absolutely dominated Colorado State from start to finish last week. They had a 31-0 lead at half with a 309-78 yd edge and won 52-0. Michigan also hosted a Mountain West team but wasn't nearly as dominant. They only led 10-3 at half and 16-10 3Q but went 75/7 td then got a 45 yard IR td for a misleading 30-10 final and only held a 269-244 yard edge. The Wolverines played both QB's Davis Warren and Anthony Orji but neither was impressive. Texas shut down Colorado St's Brayden Fowler-Nicolosi who threw for just 59 yards and an int. The Longhorns will be running with a young RB room after losing CJ Baxter in the preseason but still have plenty of talent including this year's #1 HS RB recruit Jerrick Gibson. Texas went into Tuscaloosa and won by 2 td's last year and we think they do something similar here.

## OTHER GAMES

### FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 6TH

**SMU by 17 over BYU** - These teams last met in the '22 New Mexico bowl where BYU won 24-23 (+4). SMU is already playing their 3rd game of '24 and are 2-0 (1-1 ATS) and are off a 59-7 win vs an FCS foe where QB Stone only played the first two drives. BYU is off a 41-13 win vs S.Illinois where QB Retzlaff threw for 348 yds & 3 td. Last season though BYU was -166 ypg/-17 ppg on the road while SMU was +234 ypg/+34 ppg last season at home vs FBS foes. SMU comes into this season as one of the most exp'd teams in the FBS (#7). Last season SMU was 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS as a home favorite and BYU is just 3-6 ATS since 2021 as an away dog. We like the Mustangs to put up a lot of points here and win by over 2 td's.

**NORTHWESTERN by 7 over Duke** - Teams have met for the last three seasons and there has been 7 outright upsets in the last 10 meetings. Northwestern has dropped the last five SU & ATS. Last time here in '22 Duke caused a fumble with :11 to go at the goal line and won 31-23 as a 10 pt road dog. Last year the Blue Devils (-17) slashed the Cats' for 268 yards on the ground and easily won 38-7. Last week Northwestern (-3) pulled out a close win vs Miami, Oh 13-6 and Duke (-23) gave up a field goal with :16 left but won 26-3. Northwestern HC David Braun lead his team to a 8-5 record last year and coming off a good win last week has given his team confidence. The last four trips to Evanston (smaller on campus stadium TY) in the series have gone under the total. Duke HC Diaz is 6-1 ATS as an AD but our lean is with the more talented defense so we will go with the Cats' here!

### SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 7TH

**Georgia Tech by 7 over SYRACUSE** - GT is 4-1 SU in this series (2-3 ATS). Last year Cuse used TE Dan Villari as their QB and he completed all 14 passes but GT scored a td with 2:22 left to win 31-22. The Jackets are 2-0 SU/ATS and got by a huge ACC sandwich after upsetting Florida St then beat Georgia St 35-12 (-20). Kyle McCord threw for 354 yards and 4 td's in his debut but Syracuse allowed 255 rush yards (6.5) against a young Ohio Bobcats team. The Orange did lead that game by 22 in the 4th quarter. GT is a slightly more experienced team (#24 vs #41) and Syracuse might be without their top defensive player, Marlowe Wax (110 tk), who was injured last week. GT is just 2-10 as an away favorite but this is their first time in that role under Brent Key (last was '21 vs Duke). After seeing this new Syracuse D we give GT a big edge on defense and they did hold FSU to 291 yards in the opener so our line is GT by a touchdown.

**Kansas St by 7 over TULANE** - 3rd meeting and KSt is actually 0-2 all-time vs Tulane. Last met in '22, Tulane (+14) on the road shutout KSt in the 2H to pull off the upset 17-10. Sumrall was 0-3 SU as a DD dog at Troy but was 2-1 ATS. Both teams are off dominating wins vs FCS teams as KSt won 41-6 (+315 yd) and Tulane won 52-0 (+271 yd). Tulane played multiple QB's but Mensah got the start and was 10-12 for 205 yds (2 td) and QB Thompson had 2 rushing td's. KSt is led by QB Avery Johnson and RB DJ Giddens, plus their defense has 8 starters back. While we like KSt to get the win, they are just 1-4 ATS as an away favorite the last 2 seasons and do have a big home game on deck

vs Arizona. KSt has historically not been a good road favorite in non-conf games as they are just 2-5 SU/1-6 ATS in this role since 2007. We think Tulane keeps this game close.

**PENN ST by 28 over Bowling Green** - 3rd meeting. Penn St is 2-0 & 1-0 ATS, ironically Joe Patino's 200th and 300th wins but last met in 1998. Bowling Green is 3-6 SU & 4-5 ATS since '14 in regular season games vs Big Ten teams including an outright upset 14-10 at Minnesota (+31) in '21. The Nittany Lions have not lost a non-conference regular season game since Sept. 16th, 2016 when they fell at Pittsburgh 42-39. Last week PSU (-7) went on the road and had the 457-246 yard edge beating West Virginia 34-12. Bowling Green (-15) opened up the season with a kickoff return touchdown and did not look back vs Fordham winning 41-17. BG is 3-1-1 ATS vs P4 foes last three years. The Falcons have 15 starters back from last years 7 win and only lost to Michigan last year by 25. BG is getting nearly 5 TD's here and we feel that they will keep it closer.

**MEMPHIS by 17 over Troy** - Last week Troy had a 14-6 lead at HT at home vs Nev but fell behind 2H and lost 28-26. Memphis had little trouble in their opener vs N.Ala winning 40-0 (+3 TO's). Troy is on a 7-1 ATS run in their road openers with the lone non-cover in that span coming last year at K-State. However Memphis has the huge edge in experience (#18 vs #133) and have the more exp'd coach here. 22-6 SU but since 2022 are just 6-8-1 ATS at home and just 2-5 ATS as a DD home favorite. Troy did have the first down edge vs Nev (24-17) and yards were nearly even (Nev 393-391) and Troy QB Crowder was 20-30 for 201 and RB D.Taylor ran for 103 (9.4). Troy is still a young team and while Memphis is the better squad, they are laying over 2 td's here and given their poor ATS record as a DD favorite, we'll call for this game to finish around the line.

**Pitt by 3 over CINCINNATI** - Pitt is out for revenge for last year's game where the Panthers finished with just 262 yards and they lost 27-21 (-6). Cincy has actually won five out of the last six meetings and they last met in Nippert Stadium back in '12 when they were Big East Rivals. Pitt's new offense under Kade Bell put up 55 points, 567 yards and 31 FD's against Kent St last week, all numbers that easily top last year's season highs. QB Eli Holstein (Bama transfer) was 30-40-333 and td's while Western Carolina transfer RB Desmond Reid had 145 rush and also had a 78 yd PR td. Cincy's transfer QB Brendan Sorsby (Indiana) threw for 383 yards and 2 td's in his Cincy debut. The Bearcats put up 658 yards but also allowed 438 and only won 38-20 (-31). Pat Narduzzi was 16-8 as an away dog from '15-'21 but 0-6 the last two years. The Panthers also lost all five road games last year but Cincy was 0-6 SU at home vs FBS foes. We think both teams are improved so it's a tough call and we will be more interested in the Total.

**RUTGERS by 30 over Akron** - Rutgers won the only previous meeting in 1990, 20-17. First time since 2013 that Rutgers is a 20+ point favorite vs a non-conference FBS school. Akron is 2-34 SU vs the Big Ten but last year they took Indiana in 4OT (24-14 FD and 474-282 yard edge!!!) but fell 29-27. Last matchup vs a MAC team for Rutgers was back in 2018 when they fell to Buffalo (+6) at home 42-13 and have lost three of the four vs the conference. Since '20 the Knights are 3-0 ATS as a 20 points favorite and HC Schiano is 41-23-1 ATS vs non-conference opponents. Akron (+48) did keep it close in the first half, 17-3, vs Ohio St but could not keep up with the Buckeyes and lost 52-6. Rutgers scored a TD as time expired to get the cover last week against FCS Howard. The Knights have been adding late touchdowns in blowouts so we expect them to keep the scoring going late and give them our lean here.

**FAU by 7 over Army** -First AAC game for the Black Knights as they join a conference for the second time, members of CUSA from '98-'04. The Owls have won 7 straight conference home openers and are 5-1-1 ATS. Versus Military Academy teams the Owls have one win, 33-27 (-9) vs Air Force in 2016. Army (-31) had the 375-172 rush yard edge vs Lehigh winning 42-7. FAU went into East Lansing and gave the Spartans problems but turned over it over on downs on their final three possessions falling 16-10. Army HC Monken is 14-31 SU on the road including just 2-6 in the last two years. FAU Associate Head Coach Chad Lunsford was the HC at Georgia Southern when they ran the triple option. We don't expect an upset here as the Owls looked good last week so we will take the home team by a touchdown here.

**OKLAHOMA ST by 6 over Arkansas** - Teams have met 46 times but this is the first meeting since 1980! This is Ark's first true road game vs a non-conf P5 foe since 2016, but Ark HC Pittman is 9-3 ATS as an away dog. Since 2020 Okla St is 7-1 SU in home non-conf games, but have covered just 2 of those 8 games and they failed to cover both last season, losing to SAla outright. Ark's new QB/RB duo gave fans a preview of their potential last week as Green threw 2 td's and ran for 2 td's while RB Jackson ran for 101 (12.6, 2 td) granted it was vs an FCS school. Okla St beat 2x FCS nat'l champ S.Dakota St 44-20 but the yards were nearly even (Okla St 394-388 yd edge). It is tough to go against Okla St in Boone-Pickens as the crowd will be loud for this one, but Pittman has a proven track record as a good road dog and we'll call for Ark to keep it within the line.

**AUBURN by 8 over California** - These two met last year and Cal led 10-7 at half but missed 3 FG's and lost 14-10 (+6) despite 273-230 yard and 19-12 First Down edges. The Bears had a slow start vs UC Davis last week then they were outFD'd 16-4 in the first half but led 14-13. Cal would go on to win 31-13 but lost RB Jadyan Ott to injury (Check Status). Not much can be gained from Auburn's 73-3 win over Alabama A&M. The Tigers do have 17 starters back (#44 exp) while Cal has 15 starters back (#37 exp). The Bears D faces a tough test against one of the SEC's top RB's in Jarquez Hunter (909, 5.7) but they did just hold one of the FCS' top RB's, Lan Larison to 17-62. Justin Wilcox is 17-9 as an away dog and we think his defense will be much improved. The Golden Bears are getting nearly 2 td's here which is too much to lay so we are on the dog.

**LOUISVILLE by 28 over Jacksonville St** - These two meet for the first time. UL dominated an inexperienced Austin Peay team last week, 62-0 and held a 571-106 yard edge. JSU was actually favored last week against Coastal Carolina but got behind early and never recovered in a 48-14 loss. Jeff Brohm is 3-0 ATS as a favorite of 28 points or more, though all three came against FCS teams. UL has the experience edge (#67 vs #92) and has 15 starters back while JSU only has 9. JSU did travel to South Carolina and led 28-21 3Q but down 3 they threw a late Pick-6 for a 10 point loss (+15). They also won at Florida St in '21 and covered as 27 point dogs in '20. UL is favored by four td's here and we aren't ready to throw JSU in the trash after they won 9 games last year so we will call it right at the opening line.

**NAVY by 6 over Temple** - Temple joined the AAC in 2016 and has led this series 4-3 SU/4-2-1 ATS. The over has hit in 4 straight meetings with an average line of 45.2. Last time in Annapolis '22, Temple (+14) was held to 20 rush yards and kicked a FG with 1:08 left to force OT but fell 27-20. Last year Navy (-7) handed Temple their lone AAC win as they were outgained 448-268 and lost 32-18. Last week Temple (+42) were +3 in turnovers but were outmatched at Oklahoma losing 51-3. Navy (-31) put up 264 yards on the ground to beat Bucknell 49-21. Temple has been preparing for the triple option and has shut it down the last two years so we expect the Owls to keep it within a td here.

**ILLINOIS (+) over Kansas** - Last met just last season and QB Daniels made his season debut. KU led 28-7 HT (295-122) and won 34-23 with a 539-341 yd edge. Both teams are off easy opening wins against FCS teams. Kansas is in a rare role of being an away favorite (1-2 ATS LY in that role) and Illinois is out to get revenge for LY's loss to Kansas. ILL does have a good defense with 7 starters back and will need to pressure KU QB Daniels to throw the offense out of rhythm. KU was prone to giving up yards and points on the road LY as they gave up 423 ypg/29 ppg. ILL did gain 98 ypg more than their foes allowed at home a season ago and have veteran QB Altmyer under center. We think Illinois gets their revenge on Kansas and we are calling for the Illini to get their revenge as out Underdog Play of the Week!

**Uab by 10 over ULM** - Third meeting but haven't met since '98-'99 (split mtg's). ULM HC Bryant Vincent was on Bill Clark's staff as an OC and the interim HC at UAB in '22 but was not retained after a 7-6 season. UAB is 12-11 SU/11-12 ATS vs non-conf foes and the Blazers are 7-5 SU/ATS vs current Sun Belt teams since '19. ULM was up 21-14 heading into the 4th quarter last week vs Jackson St and were able to cause three stops to pull out the 30-14 win. The Blazers are 1-11 SU and 2-10 ATS on the road the last two seasons but this year HC Dilfer has 7 starters back on his offense including veteran QB Jacob Zeno, 23-33-215-2-1 last weeks 41-3 win vs Alcorn. While ULM has just 2 starters back on offense. ULM is 1-5 and UAB is 0-10 ATS a coming off a straight up win last two years. We will give the lean to ULM here as Bryant Vincent looks to get his revenge.

**ARKANSAS ST by 13 over Tulsa** - Last met in '21 where Ark St led 14-7 1Q but trailed 24-14 HT and lost 41-34. Tulsa beat up of FCS NW State last week 62-28 (+396 yds) while Ark St scored a controversial late TD to avoid the upset vs Central Ark. Tulsa's pass D was one of the worst in the FBS LY (#121) and QB Raynor had an impressive rFr season (2543, 58%, 17-7, 380 rush) and Ark St has a talented receiver room. Ark St also has the huge edge in experience (#5 vs #119) and Tulsa was -83 ypg/-15 ppg on the road last season. Ark St got a scare LW and with games at Mich and Iowa St on deck, it is important they play well here. Ark St is 8-5 ATS in non-conf gms under HC Jones and we like Ark St to bounce back & win by almost 2 td's. **Louisiana by 17 over KENNESAW ST** - First meeting. This is Kennesaw St's first FBS home game. The Owls trailed UTSA in their opener 21-6 at half but got within 21-16 4Q before allowing a td with 3:52 left. KSt was outgained 416-253. Louisiana led Grambling 30-0 at half. It was 40-7 when LA was SOD at the Grambling3 then reached the Grambling 5 but settled for a fg. Grambling then drove 32 yards in five plays and made a 50 yard fg which cost the Cajuns backers a cover. LA has a big talent edge but KSt didn't suffer a loss by more than 10 points last year Louisiana is just 1-6 ATS as a double-digit road favorite since '20 but we feel this line is cheap at just over 2 td's so we are taking the Cajuns by 17.

**† TENNESSEE by 7 over NC State** - This game is being played in Charlotte at Bank of America Stadium. The most recent meeting was the opener in '12 when the Vols won 35-21 (-3) at the Georgia Dome. Tennessee is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS in recent meetings vs the ACC while NCSt has lost their last four vs the SEC (1-3 ATS). The Vols led the SoCon's preseason favorite, UT Chattanooga 45-0 at half. The Vols finished with 718 total yards and QB Nico lamaleava threw for 314 yards and 3 td's despite barely playing in the 2nd half. NC State played the SoCon's #2 team, Western Carolina. NCSt actually trailed 21-17 3Q. The 'Pack went 81/9 td then WCU missed a 37 yd fg and NCSt went 80 yards/5 plays td for a misleading 38-21 final. The 'Pack did finish with 521 yards and Grayson McCall threw for 318 yards and 3 td's in his Wolfpack debut. Tenn has five starters back on D, losing most of their back seven and the secondary was a huge concern entering the season. NCSt only has five starters back and must replace Bednarik Winner Peyton Wilson. The Vols are a 7' point favorite which is right where we have the line but with two talented QB's and young defenses the Over may be in consideration for a LP Totals play.

**OHIO ST by 41 over Western Michigan** - Second meeting, Ohio St won 38-12 (-32') in their lone meeting in '15. The MAC has had no chance against the Buckeyes with the last five meetings have been a combined score of 264-39 (5-0 ATS) including last week were only up 17-3 vs Akron but was able to put together a few scoring drives (404-177 yard edge). Western Michigan is on a six game SU losing streak against the Big Ten since beating Northwestern in 2016 as a 4.5 dog but last week (+24') did cover at Wisconsin. Despite a 13-27 FD edge WMU held the 14-13 lead with 14:15 left in the fourth but gave up two straight TD drives to fall 28-14. Ohio St has a bye on deck and the "struggles" in the first half should be worked out so we like the Buckeyes to continue their dominance against the MAC here.

**NEBRASKA by 14 over Colorado** - Old conference foes meet for the 73rd time. Colorado has won the last 3 meetings both SU/ATS. Last time here was om '18 where the Buffs (+3') pulled the upset 33-28. Last year Nebraska (+2) gave the ball up 4 times (13-0 H) and Colorado scored 23 unanswered to send the Huskers home for their longest losing streak (3) to the Buffaloes since ('56-'58). Last week CU (-10) played FCS powerhouse North Dakota St and played a close game but thanks to QB Sheduer Sanders 445 yards (4-1 ratio) the Buffs were able to win 31-26. QB Dylan Raiola looked sharp for the Cornhuskers (19-27-238-2-0) as they defeated UTEP (-27') 40-7. Last year Colorado had the home field advantage and were riding the momentum from a big win now their on the road playing against a much stronger Nebraska team. We will go with Rhule and Huskers' to get the win here by 2 td's.

**OKLAHOMA by 41 over Houston** - OK is 3-1 all-time vs Houston and the Sooners won the last meeting in '19 49-31 but didn't cover as 23 point home favorites. OK has won 8 straight at home (7-1 ATS) including last week against Temple 51-3 (-42). QB Jackson Arnold threw for 141 yards and 4 td's and the Sooners rushed for 220 yards. Houston was -2' last week against UNLV but were lucky to only lose 27-7. The Cougars had just 71 yards in the first half but UNLV was SOD at the UH11 and missed two fg's. UH's only td drive came on their final possession which accounted for 90 of their 235 yards. Oklahoma only has Tulane on deck so there is no look-ahead. Donovan Smith threw 2 int's last week and faces a secondary led by All-American candidate S Billy Bowman and they were #8 in our Pass Defense Efficiency last year. OK is 8-2 ATS when favored by 28 points or more. After seeing Houston's offense last week we look for Oklahoma to possibly post a shut out and win by nearly 6 td's!

**CLEMSON by 10 over Appalachian St** - Clemson has won all 5 prior meetings. Only prior meeting as FBS foes was back in '15 where Clemson (-19') led 31-0 HT and won 41-10. Clemson is off a rough 34-3 loss vs UGA where the Tigers were held to just 188 yds. App St opened 1-0 with a 38-10 win vs East Tenn St. App St has had good success against P4 teams on the road, as they have covered 6 straight and have pulled 3 outright upsets at Texas A&M, N.Carolina and S.Carolina. Since '21 Clemson is just 5-11 ATS in non-conf games. Both teams enter '24 exp'd (App St #27, Clem #35). App St has the best QB in the SBC and their defense is usually strong. App St is 5-1-1 ATS as a road dog since 2021 and we feel like they will keep this game within the line and will give Clemson a tough game.

**OREGON by 24 over Boise St** - Boise St is 3-0 SU/ATS vs Oregon. Only prior meeting here was back in '08 where Boise (+10) pulled the outright upset 37-32. Boise is off a 56-45 win at GSthrn were RB Jeanty ran for 267 yards and 6 td's! However the Boise D struggled and allowed 461 yds incl 322 pass. Now Boise faces a dynamic Oregon offense and QB Dillon Gabriel, however the Ducks only beat FCS Idaho last week 24-14. While the Ducks do have the Civil War on deck, they will not overlook a talented Boise St team, amd after a slow start in Week 1, we feel like Oregon will make it a point get their offense rolling, plus Boise's defense had issues last week vs a lesser talented foe. This is also a night game in Eugene and the crowd will play a factor here. The Ducks are also 9-4 ATS as a HF under HC Lanning. Quack Quack!

**Texas Tech by 1 over WASHINGTON ST** - These teams have not met since 1964! TT is off a close call vs FCS Abilene Christian where they were outgained 615-539 and had to stop a 2-pt try in OT to hold on. Wash St had little trouble with Portland St, leading 49-17 HT in a 70-30 win where they put up 637 yds. TT has the edge in experience as they are #57 while Wash St is #121. TT did get an impressive game from QB Morton (378, 5 td) but RB Brooks (153, 5.7 LW) is ? with an arm inj (check status). WSU got an impressive start from QB Mateer (352, 5 td). While TT is just 3-8 SU in road games under HC McGuire, 5 of those losses were to teams ranked in the top 20 at the time. We feel like this could be a high-scoring game but like TT to have a better showing in Week 2 and we will side with the more exp'd team to get a close win.

**Liberty by 17 over NEW MEXICO ST** - This is a rematch of the CUSA Title game. NMSt has a much different cast of players and HC Jerry Kill left so Tony Sanchez took over after spending the last two years on Kill's staff. Liberty had a slow start last week in their 41-24 win over Campbell. The Flames only led 17-10 at half but it was 41-17 when the Camels added a garbage time td with 1:56 left. Liberty put up 533 yards. NMSt also struggled last week to get by FCS SEMO St. The Aggies didn't take a lead until 1:57 left in the game. Aggies starting QB Parker Awad was just 5 of 17 passing for 37 yards with 1 int. Oklahoma transfer/JUCO RB Seth McGowan made impressive runs and could play a bigger role after just 11 carries last week. NMSt allowed SEMO QB Paxton DeLaurent to throw for 295 yards and now they face CUSA's best QB Kaidon Selter who threw for 319 and ran for 165 in the CUSA Title game last year. Liberty is now 0-7 ATS when favored by 20 points or more. With NMSt getting over 3 td's here we will call for the underdog Aggies to show improvement and keep it closer than expected.

**Oregon St by 6 over SAN DIEGO ST** - SDSU has lost their last 4 meetings against Oregon St. Last met last season in Corvallis and the Beavers (-24') led just 12-3 HT despite being +123 yds and failed to cover, winning 26-9. SDSU trailed FCS Texas A&M-Commerce 6-3 at HT last week before scoring 6 td's in the 2H (2 DEF td's) and winning 45-14. OSU led just 17-9 HT vs Idaho St and won 38-15. OSU is under new HC Trent Brey and come into '24 #127 in experience, while SDSU has a new HC too in Sean Lewis, who is changing up the offense. SDSU is a 2-5 ATS slide in non-conf home games, however OSU was just 2-8 ATS under former HC Smith as a road favorite. Neither team enters '24 very exp'd or with very high expectations, we like the Beavers to win, but will call for this one to finish right near the line.

**ARIZONA ST by 10 over Mississippi St** - First meeting. MSU just traveled to the state of Arizona in '22 when they beat the Wildcats 39-17 (-10'). This is new HC Jeff Lebby's first test after they cruised by Eastern Kentucky 56-7. New starting QB Blake Shapen was 15 of 20 passing for 247 yards, 3 td's and 44 rush yards and a td. Apologies to any of our customers housed our 2H going against ASU last week in their 48-7 beat down of Wyoming. The Sun Devils had 27-8FD and 499-118 yd edges. ASU has the experience edge (#68 vs #105). Kenny Dillingham is in his 2nd year and has his team clearly improved while Lebby is taking his team on their first road trip under this new staff. After last week's performance it's hard not to take ASU so we will give the Sun Devils a small lean as home favorites.

**USC by 24 over Utah St** - USC is 6-0 all-time vs Utah St but last met in 2016. Utah St is 4-2 ATS since '19 in non-conference road games as a dog of 14+ points while USC is just 4-7 as a favorite of 20+ pts. Under HC Lincoln Riley USC is 11-3 SU but just 7-7 ATS. USC is coming off a big upset (+4') win against LSU. We won our Sunday Night on Under 65.5 (Marquees 8-1 this year!!!). QB Miller Moss was solid going 27-36-378-1-0 but the defense of the Trojans held LSU to just 20 points, gave up 34 ppg last year. Utah St QB Spencer Petras got hurt but backup Bryson Barnes lead them to four td in the 2nd half to pull away to a 36-14 win. After a physical game against LSU we expect them to get a lead and get into the bye week healthy before they enter Big Ten play.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ MIAMI over Jacksonville** - A Florida showdown to open the season. After starting 8-3 JAX lost 5 of their L/6 gms. MIA made the playoffs LY, going 11-6, but lost their L/3 gms of '23. Last met in 2021 in London where JAX (+3) got a FG on the final play of the game to win 23-20. JAX has 3 new starters in the secondary and that may be an issue going up against the NFL's #1 pass attack from '23 (265 ypg). QB Tagovailoa led the NFL in passing LY and has an elite duo of WR's to throw to. However JAX has a strong pass rush with Allen (17.5 sk) and Walker (10 sk) but the Miami OL allowed 33 sacks (5.5%) LY. JAX has Lawrence back healthy, but Miami has CB Ramsey and a strong DLine that had 56 sacks in '23. Miami is 10-4 ATS as a HF under HC McDaniel and with the line around a FG we like the home squad here that was +115 ypg/+15 ppg at home in '23.

**FORECAST: Miami by 10**

**3★ ATLANTA over Pittsburgh** - ATL opens at home for a 5th straight season, hosting a new-look PIT team that has veteran QB Wilson. ATL has a new starting QB of their own in Cousins, who is coming off inj. Cousins is protected by a solid OL and has TE Pitts and WR London. PIT still has great pass rushers, but the offense looked rough for much of the preseason. PIT lacks playmakers outside of WR Pickens and they struggled to run the ball for much of '23. They also have two rookies proj'd to start on the OLine. Nine of PIT's 10 wins last fall were by 7 pts or less, which is a sign that PIT will be down in '24. ATL made some strong additions to their D and they have covered their L/2 home openers. We are high on ATL in this matchup and like them here by over a td.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Houston over INDIANAPOLIS** - These AFC South foes open the '24 season after facing off in the final regular season week in 2023. IND is in year 2 under HC Steichen and QB Richardson is back healthy after playing just 4 games LY (shoulder inj). HOU has high expectations after going 10-7 and making the AFC Divisional Round. HOU is led by young star QB Stroud and they add Pro Bowl WR Diggins to a receiver room that had WR's Collins and Dell plus TE Schultz. IND does have a strong DL, but HOU has strong tackles on the OL. HOU's run D was strong in '23, allowing just 101 ypg (3.5) and had 53 sacks and add DE Hunter. Since 2020 IND is just 3-8-1 ATS at home vs DIV foes and HOU is 8-4 ATS the L/2 years inside the division. IND is also just 0-8-1 SU/1-8 ATS in Week 1 since 2015. We'll take the Texans to get the road win here.

## OTHER PLAYS

**Baltimore vs KANSAS CITY - Thursday** - A rematch of the AFC Title game where the Chiefs (+4.5) were outgained 336-319 but were +3 in TO's and pulled the outright upset. KC is just 1-3-1 ATS in their L/5 home openers and LY they were upset at home 21-20 (-4) vs DET. BAL on the other hand is 4-1 SU/ATS in their L/5 road openers incl pulling the upset LY at Cincy (+3) 27-24. KC is led by the duo of QB Mahomes /TE Kelce and they have won 4 of the L/5 meetings (2-2-1 ATS) vs BAL. The Ravens led the NFL LY with 156 rush ypg and added Derrick Henry to their but KC only allowed 113 rush (4.5) LY and had 63 sacks! These are two of the top teams in the AFC and we expect a battle here. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

**† Green Bay vs Philadelphia - Friday** - Game played in Sao Paulo, Brazil. GB started '23 with a 3-6 record then won 6 of their L/8 to reach the playoffs. Philly's '23 started the opposite of GB as they won 10 of the first 11 games before losing 6 of their L/7. Teams last met in '22 on a Sun Night in Philly where the Eagles had a 500-342 yd edge and won 40-33 (-6). PHI brought back HC Sirani and QB Hurts is back with talented WR duo Brown/Smith and they added Saquon Barkley at RB. GB looks to have an emerging star at QB in Jordan Love and they added RB Jacobs from Vegas. GB also added a new DC in Jeff Hafley. GB closed '23 covering 7 of their L/10 games and are the slight dog here but Philly was just 1-7-2 ATS in their L/10 games as a favorite in '23.

**Minnesota by 3 over NY GIANTS** - Giants QB D.Jones is back after tearing his ACL LY. They lose RB Barkley but brought in Devin Singletary and took a WR #6 overall to help QB Jones and the NYG offense that was #29 in YPG LY. MIN's offense took a hit when 1st Rd pick QB McCarthy went down with an inj and is OFY. Sam Darnold steps in, but he has a great WR duo to throw to and they are facing a young NYG secondary. MIN HC O'Connell is 5-0-2 ATS as a road favorite & MIN is small chalk as of presstime. NYG allowed an NFL-worst 85 sacks in '23, and MIN added to their pass rush in the offseason. We have faith in MIN QB Darnold with two great WR's and an upgrade at RB in Aaron Jones. We also give the coaching edge to MIN and like the Vikings here.

**NEW ORLEANS by 7 over Carolina** - From '17-'20 NOLA was 8-1 SU/5-4 ATS vs CAR but since '21 CAR is 3-3 SU/3-2-1 ATS with all 3 SU wins being outright upsets. LY here NOLA (-5) led 14-3 HT and won 28-6 despite getting outgained 303-207 as CAR was SOD 5 times and also NOLA had a fumble return td. CAR is in year 1 under new HC Canales and he is tasked with helping former #1 overall pick QB Young bounce back after a subpar rookie season. CAR added a #1DC at WR and signed D.Johnson from PIT, but NOLA has one of the better secondaries in the NFL and they added former #2 overall pick at DE Chase Young. NOLA's offense led by RB Kamara/WR Olave faces a CAR D that could have 6 new st/frs. CAR was just 1-7-1 ATS as an away dog LY and could take time to show improvement. With the line under a td, we'll back the Saints to grab the win by a td.

**CINCINNATI by 13 over New England** - CIN open the '24 season hosting a new-look NE team led by new HC Mayo. CIN gets QB Burrow back after he played just 10 games in '23. CIN will have to do better protecting Burrow (50 sk all'd '23) but NE traded pass rusher Judon and their sack leader Barmore (8.5 sk) will miss this game. NE will start vet QB Brissett but their offense is a work in progress. NE has all 5 DB starters back, but faces a tough WR duo of Higgins/Chase. CIN has a solid DEF led by LB Wilson and DE Hendrickson (17.5 sk) and they allowed just 126 rush ypg (4.7). While CIN is just 1-4 ATS in home openers since '19, they are 9-3-2 ATS as a home favorite since '22 and NE is in uncharted waters with a new HC for the first time in 2+ decades and appear to be in full rebuild mode. We'll back the Bengals here by close to 2 td's, Who Dey!

**CHICAGO by 6 over Tennessee** - The #1 overall pick QB C.Williams debuts at home against TEN and new HC Brian Callahan. CHI made sure to help their new QB out as they added WR Keenan Allen (108 rec, 1243 yds, 7 td LY with LAC) and drafted WR Oduzwe #9 overall plus have DJ Moore (96 rec, 1364 yds LY) and TEN has 3 new starters in the secondary, but TEN has a strong DLine and made solid additions at LB. TEN's offensive success rests on the shoulders of 2nd year QB Levis, but he hit just 58% with an 8-4 ratio in 9 games LY. He has a talented WR room, but the Bears have an improved secondary and are led by DE Sweat (12.5 sk) and TEN has a new rookie LT and TEN allowed 64 sks, plus they lose pro bowl RB Henry. TEN was just 2-6 ATS on the road LY and we'll back the Bears to get the win here by just under a td.

**BUFFALO by 4 over Arizona** - ARZ travels across the country to open their ssn. BUF comes into '24 looking a bit different. They lost WR's Diggins and Davis plus both starting S's, top sack man and their starting C. Also standout LB Milano is OFY after an inj in the preseason. ARZ gets QB Murray back and will start the season healthy, plus they have #1DC WR Harrison Jr and TE

BUF QB Allen was TO prone LY (18 int) and they will rely more on RB Cook. ARZ was 4-2 ATS LY as an away dog vs non-DIV foes LY and BUF was just 2-4 ATS as a home favorite vs non-DIV foes. While we think BUF wins, we like ARZ to keep this game close.

**LA CHARGERS by 6 over Las Vegas** - The home team has won and covered the L/6 mtgs in this AFC West series. LAC brought in Jim Harbaugh as the new HC and QB Herbert is still one of the best in the NFL, though he was dealing with a foot inj in preseason. LAC does lose their top RB and 2 of their best WR's and that unit is a big ? entering '24. LY went with Antonio Pierce as their full-time HC and QB Minshew, but they lost their top RB from LY and the OL is a work in progress and here they face Bosa/Mack off the edge. LAC has invested in their OLine and it will be tested here. Given the recent series history we will back LAC to get a win in Harbaugh's debut on the Bolts sideline.

**TAMPA BAY by 7 over Washington** - WAS is launching the Jayden Daniels era on the road in TB vs a Bucs squad fresh off a DIV title in '23. TB was 3-1-1 as chalk LY, however WAS was an impressive 6-2 ATS as an AD LY. WAS is led by new HC Quinn, who brings a DEF mindset to town. WAS does lose their #2 and #3 WR's and TB does bring back 10 st/frs on DEF that recorded 53 sks and allowed just 314 ypg over the L/8 gms of '23. TB was #7 in the NFL LY allowing just 19.1 ppg. TB has great skill position players around QB Mayfield and WAS allowed the most pass ypg a season ago (262 ypg). WAS's strength on DEF is their DL but TB has a strong OL. In the heat & humidity we feel like the blitzing Bucs defense will get rookie Daniels fits here and win by a td.

**SEATTLE by 6 over Denver** - These teams have some history as they met in Super Bowl 48 and more recently struck a deal for QB Russell Wilson, though he no longer in Denver. After 14 years under HC Carroll, SEA has a new head coach. They brought in Ravens DC Mike Macdonald to lead the Hawks. Denver brought in rookie QB Bo Nix and he won the job, but could be in trouble against an improved-looking SEA defense led by a strong pass rush and they have a great CB duo. 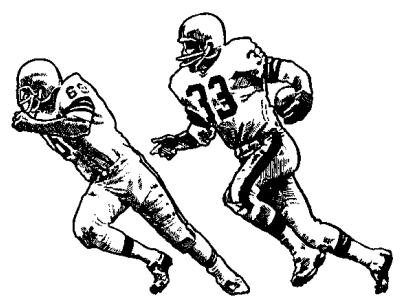
