Rematch of the 2017 National Championship Game which saw Bama rally and win in OT 26-23 (-3'). Saban is playing in his 9th Title game and is 7-2 SU including LY when they smoke Ohio St 52-24 but he's yet to win back-to-back CFB Titles. This is a rematch of the SEC Title game which Bama won as nearly a td underdog 41-17.

UGA was the SEC East fav this year what many felt was the best D in the country. The Dawgs won their opener vs Clemson despite not scoring an offensive td. JT Daniels started 3 of the F4 at QB but battled inj's so UGA turned to former w/o Stetson Bennett. The Dawgs D didn't allow a 1st half td until the 7th game and Tenn was the only team to top 13 pts in the reg ssn with just 17! The Dawgs were 12-0, winning 11 straight gms by 24 pts or more but met their match vs Bama who put up 41 points and 536 yds. UGA allowed 260 ypg and held foes 141 ypg below their avg. QB Bennett has been solid with 2638 (64%, 27-7) and true frosh TE Bowers has been outstanding, leading with 846 (16.3). The Dawgs allowed just 9.6 ppg and are led by 1st Tm AA's DT Jordan Davis and LB Nakobe Dean.

Bama had to replace a wealth of talent on offense with 4 1st round DC's gone at the skill positions. The Tide crushed Miami in the opener and was 5-0 after beating Ole Miss (led 35-0). They held a +143 yd edge over A&M but all'd the GW fg as time expired. They crushed Miss St in the 2H & won by 40, pulled away late vs Tenn to win by 28 then had close wins over Ark & Auburn where they trailed 10-0 4Q & won in 4OT. In the SEC Title they let up UGA's vaunted D for 41 pts and 536 yds. Bryce Young threw for 4,503 (68%, 46-5) but has lost one of his top targets in WR Metchie (OFY). The Tide's D allows 300 ypg and holds foes 117 ypg below their avg and LB Will Anderson (15.5 sks) won the Nagurski and was SEC DEF POY. UGA's D will be extremely motivated after the poor SEC Title game and this will be a close game so we call for a low scoring affair.

These teams last met in the 2019 Semi-Finals. The Bison won 42-14 finishing with a 541-298 yd edge. However 218 of their yards were on just 3 plays, a 75 yd pass, a 70 yd run & a 73 yd pass all for TD's. It was NDSU's 36th straight win & they would go on to win their 8th FCS Title in 9 years. Montana St made only 1 previous FCS Championship in 1984, when they beat Louisiana Tech 19-6. So neither team has ever lost in the Championship game.

Montana St was the #8 seed. In the playoffs they beat OVC Champ UT Martin 26-7, then handed returning FCS Champion & #1 seed Sam Houston their first loss in 2 yrs, 42-19. They then beat 20-14 runner-up South Dakota St, which handed NDSU their only loss this year, 31-17. This despite being led by frosh QB Mellott, who became the starter just days before the UT Martin game, when former NC St transfer QB McKay surprisingly entered the transfer portal. Mellott while throwing for just 461 yds is the #2 rusher with 705 yds (6.4, 10 td). The bobcats also have a 1,000+ yd RB & WR in RB Ilanese (1539, 5.2 ypc, 10 td) & WR McCutcheon (1015, 18.1 ypc, 7 td).

NDSU was the #2 seed & in the playoffs beat Southern Illinois 38-7, then #7 seed ETSU 27-3 & held on to beat #3 seed JMU 20-14. The Bison spread the ball around on offense with 2 QB's combining for 2,131 pass & 801 rush, 3 RB's rushing for 466+ yds each, while WR Christian Watson leads with 740 receiving.

It is said that "Defense wins Championships" and both are in the #10 in Total Defense & NDSU has the #1 scoring Defense while Montana St has the #2. The Bobcats held the #3 Scoring Offense of Sam Houston (46.0 ppg) to just 19 pts. NDSU held the #5 Scoring Offense of James Madison to just 14 pts. Many of the Bobcats remember how the big plays were their downfall in 2019. In what should be a close game we look for both defenses to step up once again and keep the scoring down.

4★ La Chargers over LAS VEGAS - SNF - The Raiders have had some fortunate breaks over the past 3 weeks to stay in playoff contention with a win over a Browns squad that was missing most of their starters (incl top 2 QB's) due to Covid, a victory over a DEN squad without QB Teddy Bridgewater and a 3 pt road win LW against the Colts (GW 33-yd FG as time expired) who got back QB Carson Wentz (Covid protocols) the day of the game (IND held to ssn-low 262 yds). The Chargers meanwhile find themselves controlling their own playoff destiny following a 21 pt victory over the Broncos. In their 1st meeting on MNF back in early October, the Chargers (-3') jumped out to a 21-0 lead in the eventual 14 pt victory. While the Chargers have failed to cover 11 of their L/17 inside of the AFC West, we like them here as the Raiders finally match up against a 1st string QB that torched them for 3 TD's in their earlier meeting.

FORECAST: La Chargers by 10
3★ PHILADELPHIA over Dallas - Saturday - After their 4th straight win LW on the road against WAS where they overcame a 16-7 HT deficit, the Eagles return home for the ssn finale with a solid shot of grabbing one of the WC spots in the NFC. The Cowboys meanwhile suffered a 3 pt home loss to ARZ to move to 11-5 on the year (#4 in the NFC). In their 1st matchup of the ssn back in Wk 3, DAL (-3') picked up their 4th consec win over PHI in Arlington with a massive 27-12 FD edge. While DAL is a solid 21-8 ATS vs DIV foes dating back to '17 including a perfect 5-0 ATS this season with a 14 pt avg cover, the Eagles (beat DAL the past 2 yrs at home) have much more on the line this time around (DAL could be resting or limiting starters).

FORECAST: PHILADELPHIA by 7
2★ Seattle (+) over ARIZONA - The Cardinals still find themselves in the mix for the NFC West Title following a huge road win over the Cowboys a week ago as nearly a TD dog. The Seahawks meanwhile are staring at their worst record in over a decade despite a 51-29 win over the Lions a week ago where WR DK Metcalf pulled in 3 TD's. In their 1st meeting of the ssn back in late November, the Cardinals (+3) went into the Pacific NW and came away with a 23-13 upset victory (bkp QB McCoy 35-44-328-2-0 for the inj'd Murray). The Cardinals have struggled in recent HG's with a 0-4 SU/ATS mark (listed as chalk in each of them). The Seahawks meanwhile have gone 7-2 ATS as a DIV AD. With ARZ's lack of success in the desert and SEA's offensive output a week ago, we're expecting the visitor to stay close in this one.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Kansas City by 13 over DENVER - Saturday - Following a pivotal loss LW in CIN (GW 20-yd FG as time expired) to fall behind the Titans for the #1 spot in the AFC, the Chiefs head into "Mile High" looking to knock off the Broncos for the 13th consecutive time (22-9 win as 10 pt favorite back in early Nov). With QB Teddy Bridgewater out for a 2nd straight game for DEN a week ago, Drew Lock and the Broncos offense sputtered yet again in a 34-13 loss to the Chargers. The Broncos are staring at DD losses for the 4th time in the past 5 years with a defeat here while the Chiefs have covered 4 of their past 6 AG's. With KC clearly having some more work to do after LW's surprising defeat, we have no issue leaning in their direction in this one (KC 13 pt avg MOV vs DEN in 12-gm winning streak).

DETROIT by 4 over Green Bay - The Packers' 37-10 victory LW against the Vikings (4★ Newsletter Winner!) saw them claim the top overall spot in the NFC. The Lions meanwhile return home from the Pacific NW after a 22 pt loss to the Seahawks (SEA 29-20 FD & 497-357 yd edge). In their previous meeting back in Wk 2, the Packers (-11') picked up a 35-17 victory on MNF (QB Rodgers 22-27-255-4-0) for their 5th straight win in the series (DET had won 4 in a row from '17-'18). With the Packers having nothing left to play for in this one with starters likely sitting out, we expect the Lions (led 17-14 at HT in their 1st meeting) to end the year on a high note against their rival (6-2 ATS run coming in).

MINNESOTA by 2 over Chicago - The Vikings return home following a 27 pt loss in Lambeau to the Packers (bkp QB Mannion 22-36-189-1-0 for Cousins who was on Covid list) which eliminated them from playoff contention. The Bears on the other hand have picked up victories in each of the past 2 weeks including a 26 pt win over the Giants LW in Soldier Field (249-151 yd edge). In their MNF meeting back in December, the Vikings (-6') won for just the 2nd time in the last 7 meetings against the Bears despite substantial FD (24-13) and yard (370-193) deficits (CHI 3 TO's). Despite just a 3-10 ATS mark against DIV foes coming in for the Bears, we expect them to hang within a FG against the favored Vikings who have failed to cover 12 of their past 14 as home chalk.

New England by 10 over MIAMI - Following their 1st loss since the end of October LW on the road in Nashville where they were held to just 3 pts and 256 yds (3.5★ Top Play LP & 3★ Newsletter Winner on the Titans!), the Dolphins return home looking for their 3rd straight victory over the Patriots. NE meanwhile heads to South Beach after snapping their 2-game losing skid LW at home against the Jags in easy fashion with a 50-10 victory (HC Belichick's 20th 10-win ssn). In their most recent meeting way back in the ssn-opener, the Dolphins (+3) gave NE and rookie QB Mac Jones a 17-16 defeat despite the Patriots finishing with 24-16 FD and 393-259 yd edges. With NE looking for some much needed revenge this time around while also having covered 4 of their past 5 away contests overall, we have no issue giving the visitor a DD edge in this one as they're still alive for the top spot in the AFC East.

Indianapolis by 17 over JACKSONVILLE - After a narrow home loss to the Raiders a week ago where they were held to a ssn-low 262 yds, the Colts head South to take on a Jags squad that's a loss away from earning the 1st overall pick in the NFL Draft for the 2nd straight season. JAX did have their share of struggles a week ago in Foxboro with the Patriots handing them their 17th consec road loss (NE 32-11 FD & 471-253 yd edges in 40 pt win). In their 1st matchup of the year back in the middle of November, the Colts (-10) picked up a closer than expected 23-17 victory. With IND still needing a win here to clinch an AFC Wildcard berth and JAX failing to cover 7 straight overall, we'll go ahead and give the visitor a substantial lean in this one as they've covered 6 consecutive AG's coming in.

BUFFALO by 21 over Ny Jets - Following a 14 pt home victory LW against the Falcons where they overcame 3 int's from Josh Allen, the Bills are back in BUF for a 2nd straight week to take on a Jets squad that nearly pulled off yet another surprising home upset LW against the Bucs (TB GW 33-yd TD pass w:/15 left). In their 1st meeting of the season back in the middle of November, the Bills (-13) picked up their 3rd consecutive victory over the Jets in easy fashion with a 489-366 yd edge (ssn-best 45 pts). With BUF still needing a win here to clinch the AFC East and the Jets having failed to cover 18 of their L/24 inside their DIV, we expect the home squad to pick up a commanding victory (BUF 8-4 ATS in recent HG's).

TAMPA BAY by 6 over Carolina - The Panthers continued their losing ways a week ago inside of the Superdome with the Saints (held to just 10 pts & 178 yds) handing them their 6th straight defeat (0-6 ATS run). The Bucs meanwhile return home following a narrow 28-24 win against the Jets with Tom Brady having another tremendous effort (410 yds, 3 TD's incl GW 33-yd pass w:/15 left). In their previous 21 matchup 2 weeks ago, the Bucs (-14) picked up a 32-6 victory for their 3rd straight win over the Panthers (CAR held to less than 300 yds for the 4th time in 5 gms). With TB potentially watching the scoreboard here to see if they can move up the playoff standings and the Panthers going a surprisingly 9-4 ATS as an AD, we'll go ahead and call for the visitor to stay within the line in this one.

Tennessee by 14 over HOUSTON - Following an easy 34-3 win in Nashville against the Dolphins (3.5★ Top Play LP Winner on TEN!) that saw them clinch the AFC South for the 2nd consecutive season and take over the #1 spot in the AFC (KC lost to CIN), the Titans head into HOU to take on

a Texans squad that dropped a 16 pt contest on the road against the 49ers. In their earlier meeting back in late November, the Texans (+10) picked up a shocking road upset against the Titans thanks to a 5-0 TO edge (TEN 26-15 FD & 420-190 yd edges). With revenge on the mind of the Titans this time around along with covering 4 of their 5 DIV matchups on the year, we have no issue giving the visitor a substantial lean in this one.

Washington by 8 over NY GIANTS - After a 4th straight loss LW at home against the Eagles in a game that they led 16-7 at HT (4 pt defeat), WAS is back on the road for a 3rd time in a 4-week span to take on a Giants squad that was a dealt a 26 pt defeat LW on the road against the Bears (NYG ssn-low 151 yds). These 2 DIV rivals met way back in Wk 2 with WAS (-3') connecting on a GW 43-yd FG on the final play for a 30-29 victory (ended 5-game losing streak to the Giants). While there's nothing but pride on the line this time around, we like the fight that WAS had against the Eagles a week ago following a dismal effort in Wk 16 vs the Cowboys.

New Orleans by 7 over ATLANTA - Following an 8 pt home win over the Panthers to move back to .500 on the season (kept their playoff hopes alive), the Saints head on the road where they've covered 10 of their past 14 matchups. The Falcons meanwhile were held to just 265 yds in a 14 pt road loss in snowy BUF. In their 1st meeting of the season back in early November, the Falcons (+6) would jump out to a 17-3 lead in the 4Q before needing a 29-yd FG as time expired for a 27-25 road win. With ATL struggling overall inside of the NFC South with ATS losses in 6 of their L/8, we'll go ahead and call for the Saints to knock off the Falcons for the 4th time in 5 tries.

BALTIMORE by 8 over Pittsburgh - Following a critical loss LW against the Rams where QB Lamar Jackson missed his 3rd straight game with an ankle injury (Rams GW 7-yd TD pass w:/57 left), the Ravens are back at home for a 2nd straight week to take on a Steelers squad that heads to BAL on short rest after a MNF home matchup against the Browns. These 2 met a little more than a month ago in Heinz Field with PIT (+4') picking up a 20-19 upset win (3rd straight win in the series). While there's an excellent chance that PIT and BAL will both miss the playoffs for the 1st time since 2013, we expect the Ravens to get the win in this one as they've covered 8 of their L/11 HG's overall and appear to be a little more solid on both sides of the ball.

CLEVELAND by 6 over Cincinnati - The Bengals picked up a crucial home upset of the Chiefs a week ago (GW 20-yd FG as time expired) to win the AFC North for the 1st time S'15 (QB Burrow 446 pass yds & 4 TD's). The Browns meanwhile return home on short rest following a MNF visit to PIT. While the Bengals have gone a solid 4-1 ATS vs DIV foes that includes outright upsets on the road against the Steelers and Ravens, they did struggle in their home meeting with the Browns back in November with CLE taking advantage of a 3-0 TO edge in a 41-16 win (CIN 25-14 FD edge). That victory by CLE was actually their only cover (as of presstime) against the AFC North in the past 12 tries! Despite the Browns failing to cover 7 of their past 10 HG's overall and sputtering on the offensive end in recent '21 contests, the Bengals could be resting a handful of starters after claiming the DIV a week ago.

LA RAMS by 2 over San Francisco - The 49ers picked up a big win LW at home against the Texans (currently #6 in NFC playoff order) with rookie QB Trey Lance throwing a pair of 2H TD's in the 16 pt victory. The Rams meanwhile return home after a narrow 1 pt road win over the Ravens where they got a GW 7-yd TD pass w:/57 left. In LA's earlier trip to the Bay Area for MNF, the 49ers (+3') won for a 5th straight time while holding the Rams to a ssn-low 10 pts and 278 yds. While recent history is certainly in the favor of the visitor in this one along with a 7-3 ATS mark as an AD, we'll go ahead and give the 49ers an excellent chance to keep this contest close.
