4★ Cincinnati over MIAMI, OH - 128th meeting for the Victory Bell! Each team has 60 wins in the series (60-60-7). Last season Miami snapped CIN's 16 game win streak in the series with a 31-24 OT win despite CIN having a 538-358 yd edge. Miami has just 1 game under their best (bye last week) and they lost at N'Western 13-6 in a game they only put up 267 yds. CIN is off a 28-27 loss to Pitt where they actually led 17-6 HT (285-168) and 27-6 3Q. CIN QB Sorsby has 681 pass yds (64%, 5-1) through the F/2 gms. Miami allowed 4 sks in the opener and CIN has 5 sks in their F/2 gms. Just 2 times s/08 has CIN not been a DD favorite in this game, and that was in 2017-18 where they were underdogs, but won both of those games outright. As of presstime the line is under a fg and we feel like that is extremely cheap as Cincy is playing with legit revenge. Give us the Beacats by DD's! **FORECAST: Cincinnati by 14**

3★ Indiana over UCLA - First meeting for the new conference foes. This will mark the longest road trip for the Hoosiers (2,166 miles). UCLA has not played a B10 foe since Neb in '15. The Bruins had a bye last week after nearly losing to Hawaii in week 1. UCLA (-14) was down 10-0 at half but came back to kick a GW FG with :56 left to escape with a 16-13 win. Indiana is coming off two wins where their offense put up 414 and 701 yds while their defense has only allowed 182 and 121 in those contests. Their 77 points and 701 yards against Western Illinois (-44) broke school records. Both teams have brought in 20+ transfers along with new HC's. Indiana has a big coaching edge with Cignetti who is 8-3 ATS on the road and they are laying under a touchdown against a team with a weak home crowd. We like the Hoosiers to win comfortably. **FORECAST: INDIANA by 14**

3★ Boston College (+) over MISSOURI - BC makes their first trip to Columbia and already have one outright upset road win in the Bill O'Brien era when they beat FSU a few weeks ago as 16' point dogs. Mizzou has yet to allow a point this season but has only played Murray St and Buffalo. This marks the first time they've opened the season with two straight shut outs since 1935! Last week their star WR Luther Burden left the game with illness/injury but should be back to play here. BC's Thomas Castellanos is completing 73% with a 6-0 ratio. They come in well rested after crushing Duquesne 56-0 (-33'). The Eagles D has allowed just 214 ypg including 41 rush ypg (1.6). Missouri has won 19 straight non-conference home games (12-6-1 ATS) but Drinkwitz is just 6-10-1 ATS as a home favorite. The value here is on the underdog Eagles who are getting over 2 td's and have already proven they can play well in hostile environments. **FORECAST: Missouri by 8**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Toledo (+) over MISSISSIPPI ST - Toledo gets to experience the Cow Bells for the first time. Miss St has won 11 straight non conf home games. New HC Jeff Lebby took Miss St to the desert last week and trailed 30-3 but rallied to only lose by a td. Toledo's lone win against an SEC school was in '15 when they beat #18 Arkansas 16-12. The Rockets come in 2-0 but they've only beaten Duquesne and UMass. QB Tucker Gleason is only hitting 50% but does have a 6-0 ratio. Miss St QB Blake Shapen has hit 69% with a 5-0 ratio. Miss St has their SEC opener on deck against Florida. The Bulldogs are laying DD's here but the Rockets have the coaching edge under Jason Candle and they feel this is a rare shot to pull an upset over an SEC school. We won't quite call for Toledo to win but we do think they keep it ultra-competitive. **FORECAST: MISSISSIPPI ST by 4**

2★ † Washington over Washington St - The second time the Apple Cup has been played at Lumen Field ('11), home of the Seahawks. This marks the first time that this matchup is a non-conference game since 1917, with UW going to the B10 TY. Washington has the 76-33-6 series edge and has won 12 of the last 14 while being 10-4 ATS. Last year the Huskies (-16) had the P12 championship on deck and gave up a game tying TD with 5:58 left then drove down the field to kick a GW FG as time expired. Wash St has put up 107 points but UW's defense has only allowed 12 points and an avg 229 yds. WSU had a 27-10 lead over Texas Tech at half last week but were actually outgained 261-181. UW has gone 3-1 SU/ATS in their neutral site games the last 2 ssn. The Huskies have dominated in this series and Wash St wasn't as good as the final score indicated LW. **FORECAST: Washington by 13**

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 12TH

Arizona St vs TEXAS ST - First meeting. TXSt played a B12 team just last year and went to Baylor (+27'), pulling of the upset 42-31. TXSt is off a convincing win vs UTSA where they led 35-3 HT (394-137) where QB McCloud threw for 309 yards recorded 4 total td's. Ariz St is also off a win, taking down Miss St 30-23 at home where ASU only threw for 69 yards but RB Skattebo ran for 262 yds (7.9) and the Sun Devils run D only allowed 30 yards (1.2). ASU did allow Miss St to throw for 268 yds last week and now face an even better QB in McCloud and a TXSt pass attack that put up 309 yards against a solid UTSA secondary. ASU has gone just 2-8 ATS as an away favorite since 2018. Both teams are on short rest here but TXSt gets the benefit of not having to travel on short rest.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 13TH

KANSAS by 6 over UNLV - Rematch of the Guaranteed Rate Bowl LY where KU led 28-10 HT (333-151) but UNLV did cut it to 28-24 3Q before KU pulled away and won 49-36. KU QB Daniels DNP in that game but KU did throw for 449 yds & 6 td's. UNLV is off to a 2-0 start and already has a win over B12 Houston in the opener, where they held them to 259 yds and 7 pts. KU is off a loss at Illinois (2nd straight outright winner on Illinois for Underdog POW!) where QB Daniels had 3 int's incl a pick-six. Granted it was vs FCS Utah Tech, UNLV ran for 503 yds (8.1) last week and their DEF has held their F/2 foes to under 300 yds. UNLV HC Odom is 7-0 ATS on the road as the HC here, but KU HC Leipold is 7-1 ATS since '22 as a home favorite. With angles favoring both teams and the line dropping to around a td we will call for this game to finish right around the line.

KANSAS ST by 10 over Arizona - While both teams are in B12, this will count as a non-conf game. KSt comes in off a 34-27 win at Tulane where they were outgained 491-396 but were +2 TO's incl a fumble return td that put KSt up for good. Ariz only beat FCS N.Ariz 22-10 last week where WR McMillan only had 2 rec for 11 yds after 10 rec for 304 yds and 3 td in week 1. Ariz did allow 471 yds and 39 pts to NMex in the opener incl 211 rush (5.6) and KSt has ran for 283 (9.1) and 215 (6.5) in the F/2 games led by RB Giddens who has B2B 100+ yard games and KSt's OL has not allowed a sack through 2 gms. KSt's pass rush has gotten off to a strong start with 9 sacks in the F/2 games, but they did allow 342 pass yds to Tulane last week and now face a strong pass attack. However KSt is 12-2 ATS as a home favorite since 2022 and you have an experienced coach used to big games against a first-year HC coaching in a tough environment.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 14TH

Oklahoma St by 28 over TUTSA - Okla St has won the last 9 meetings vs Tulsa. Okla St is off a 39-31 OT win vs Ark where they allowed 648 yds but were +2 TO's incl a 73-yd pick-six. Tulsa is off a 28-24 loss at Ark St. Okla St is #1 in experience this season & Tulsa is #119. Okla St should also have a good number of fans at this game as these schools are only 70 miles apart. Tulsa is also on an 0-6 ATS run in home non-conf games with the avg loss coming by 38 ppg incl last season's 66-17 loss at home vs Oklahoma (-303 yds). Okla St RB Gordon should have a bigger game after only rushing for 49 yards (2.9) LW and QB Bowman did throw for 326 yds LW. The Cowboys do have a big game vs Utah on deck, but Tulsa has not been overly impressive this season and Okla St has the superior talent at every position.

TEXAS TECH by 7 over North Texas - Teams are separated by 300 miles. The series is tied 4-4 but they have not met since '01. North Texas is on a 9-4 ATS run vs Power 5 opponents with their lone road win at Arkansas in '18, 44-17 (+6). Texas Tech under HC Joey McGuire are 7-9 ATS as a favorite but are 11-3 SU at home. The Mean Green are coming off a 35-20 win over SF Austin but in week one (+6) upset South Alabama on the road thanks to 28 points in the 3Q winning 52-38. Texas Tech has put up good offensive numbers so far going for 539 and 491 yards but their defensive has given up 615 and 416 yards. In week one they survived in OT vs Abilene Christian and LW (+1) lost to Washington St 37-16 and have -3 TOs but were +76 net yd's. We like Texas Tech to win here but for the Mean Green to keep it within the line!

Alabama by 17 over WISCONSIN - Third meeting. Teams last met in the '15 opener in Arlington, Tx. Alabama outgained Wisconsin 502-268, outrushed 238-40 and allowed 21 unanswered points in a 35-17 loss (-12'). This is Bama's first Big 10 road game since '11 when they beat Penn St in State College and they have won nine straight road openers. The last time Wisco was a DD home dog was LY when they hosted Ohio St (+14'), were only down 17-10 in the 4Q but fell 24-10 in Camp Randall. LW Bama (-30') only lead 21-16 w/ 6:45 to go but were able to stop USF on downs twice and scored on their last 3 possessions winning 42-16. Wisco (-17) held South Dakota to 237 total yd's and won 27-13. Alabama is 8-2 SU/ATS vs the Big 10 recently so we will continue the trend here and have the Tide here.

ILLINOIS by 14 over Central Michigan - First meeting. CMU is 5-3 ATS on the road vs non-conference foes dating back to their road upset vs Kansas (+5) in '17 winning 45-27. LY the Chippies played a Big 10 opponent falling to Michigan St (+14) 31-7, being held to a ssn low 219 yds of offense. Since '16, Illinois is 4-1 SU but 1-4 ATS vs the MAC, LY they were down 28-27 w/ 2:16 left and kicked a GW FG with :08 left. The Illini are coming of a ranked upset win, were they stopped Kansas on there last four possessions and pulled off the 23-17 (+4') win for our **2nd straight Underdog winner in PowerSweep**. CMU is 5-0 ATS as dog of 15 plus points the last two ssn's including an outright upset LY (+16) at South Alabama. Illinois was 0-3 ATS vs non-conf LY but this year they are off to a 2-0 start but with the presstime line being right around 3 td's we will go with CMU with the points.

FLORIDA ST by 13 over Memphis - These two meet for the first time since 1990. FSU badly needs a win after starting 0-2 with losses to G'Tech and BC. The 'Noles are fresh off a bye though and after two turns as a double-digit favorite they are laying less than a touchdown at home. Memphis is 2-0 after beating Troy 38-17 (-19). Their D has allowed just 218 ypg in their first two. FSU run D has been gashed for 227 (5.1) ypg but that was against two dual threat QB's which Memphis doesn't have. This is Memphis' road opener. They went 5-0 on the road last year but were just 3-11 SU on the road from '20-'22. It's hard to trust Florida St after two upset losses but it's also hard to trust Memphis on the road (6-11 ATS L4Y). Coming off the bye week we expect Norvell to get FSU's offense straightened out and with the line under a touchdown we will take the 'Noles by double-digits.

NC STATE by 28 over Louisiana Tech - These two last met in '21 when NCSt was -18' but only won 34-27. LT is fresh off a bye and in week 1 they only beat Nicholls 25-17 (-7'). Jack Turner started at QB that game but left with an injury and r'f'r Blake Baker completed just 50% for 207 with 1 td and 2 int's. NCSt had just 143 yards, 3 TO's and failed to score an offensive td against Tennessee last week. LT's D allowed 418 ypg last year including 233 rush ypg (5.5) and only has five starters back. LT is 1-18 SU/5-14 ATS on the road the last three years and are just 3-9 ATS as an away dog under Cumbe. Seven of their 11 road losses under Cumbe are by more than 21 points which is where this line currently is. Dave Doeren is 9-4 ATS off a SU loss the last four years. NCSt is in a Tennessee/Clemson sandwich but given LT's struggles on the road we are giving the Wolfpack a 4 td edge.

MICHIGAN by 24 over Arkansas St - First meeting. Mich is off a 31-12 loss vs Texas where they trailed 24-3 HT (-191 yds) and lost 31-12 (-3 TO's). Ark St is 2-0 this season but barely beat FCS Central Ark and came back from a 1H deficit vs Tulsa to win by 4. Ark St is led by QB Raynor who has 572 yds (57%, 3-2) and is also Ark St's #1 rusher (122, 3.6). Mich still has a strong defense, but their offense is looking unimpressive early on this season (277 ypg) and their leading rusher has just 112 yds (5.6) through the F/2 gms. Ark St is just 1-6 ATS in their L7 gms as a DD road dog of 20+ pts but Mich is just 2-6-2 ATS since 2022 as a home favorite of 20+ points. With Mich off Texas and USC at home on deck, this is a sandwich game, so we will call for this game to finish right at the line.

BUFFALO by 6 over UMass - Will be the 15th meeting. Last met in '22 where Buffalo was +260 yds and led 24-7 HT in a 34-7 win. This is the 3rd straight MAC game for UMass (who will join the MAC next season) as they lost to E.Mich and Toledo this season. UMass has put up 357 ypg but they are only avg'g 3.1 yards per carry and their OL has allowed 11 sacks (15.7%) in 2 games. Buffalo did well in the opener, beating a good FCS Lafayette team 30-13 (+180 yds) and last week were shutout 38-0 at Mizzou (-349 yds). Buffalo is an inexp'd team (#120) and their QB Ogbonna is hitting just 45% and faces veteran HC Don Brown and a defense that held Toledo to 258 yds. We see Buffalo as the better team, but UMass is a scrappy team and call for this one to finish at the line.

Coastal Carolina by 13 TEMPLE - First meeting. Coastal is 5-2 SU in non-conference road contests and overall are 15-6 in road games since '20. In their ssn opener at Jax St, CC (+3') put up 552 yds and were up 48-13 mid way through the 4th winning 55-27. Since '23 Temple is 0-6 SU/ATS as a DD underdog including being 0-2 this year, being out scored 89-14. This marks Temple's first game against an SBC foes and are 2-8 ATS vs non-conf foes the last three years. The Owls have won 4 of their last 5 home openers but are 2-3 ATS in those matchups. Coastal is 3-0 ATS as a DD favorite including last weeks 40-21 (-16') win over William & Mary. The last 5 times 5 times CC has been a DD fav on the road the game has gone under the total, we expect it to be a close matchup and will go with the home team with the points here!

FLORIDA by 3 over Texas A&M - Battle of two teams that lost in week 1 but bounced back with lopsided wins over FCS foes last week. A&M won their only prior trip to The Swamp but that was back in 2017 and they've lost their last 10 true road games! The Aggies are 1-6 SU but 4-3 ATS in true road openers. Florida was without Graham Mertz last week so they went to phenom true frosh DJ Lagway who threw for 456 yards against Samford, breaking Chris Leak's frosh record. Napier has stated he plans to use both Mertz and Lagway this week. A&M is off a 52-10 win over McNeese St. Connor Weigman has only completed 52% with a 2-2 ratio. The Gators have actually lost six straight vs FBS foes but five of those have come against teams that were ranked in the top 18. Lagway is 6'3" 240 lbs with an accurate big arm. His emergence gives Florida a more explosive dimension and Weigman has struggled in the new offense. Napier is 20-11-1 as an underdog with 11 outright upsets and we will take Florida to win outright. We also cashed our Sept Totals GOM back in '20 when A&M beat UF 41-38 (Over 59) and could look at the Over with Lagway sparking UF's offense!

Oregon by 6 over OREGON ST - 128th meeting of the Civil War. The home team is on a 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS run since 2016. Oregon is 2-0, but are off 2 less than stellar performances as they only beat Idaho 24-14 and were outgained by Boise St in a 37-24 win. OSU is also off to a 2-0 start and are off a 21-0 win at SDSt where they held them to 179 yds and were +16 FD's! Oregon struggled to contain Boise's run game last week (221, 6.7) and now face an OSU rush attack that has put up 362 (6.2) and 237 (4.6) in the F/2 games. OSU's top 2 RB's Griffin (249, 6.6) and Hankerson (226, 5.7) each have over 200 yards through the F/2 games. Oregon is only rushing for 108 ypg (3.0) and their OL has all'd 7 sacks & through 2 gms OSU's run D has allowed just 77 ypg (3.8). On paper Oregon is the better team, but this is OSU's super bowl after the Pac-12 dissolved on they were left without a conf. We like the Beavers to keep it close with Oregon.

West Virginia by 1 over PITTSBURGH - 107th meeting of the Backyard Brawl. Last time here was the '22 opener where WVU led 31-24 4Q but Pitt took the lead on a pick-6 and won 38-31. LY the yards were even 211-211 and WVU (led by bkp QB Marchiol) won 17-6. Pitt is 2-0 and are off a comeback win vs Cincy where they trailed 27-6 late 3Q but kicked the GW FG with 17 sec left. WVU rebounded last week with a 49-14 win vs FCS Albany. Pitt's offense has looked good so far, putting up 570 and 498 yds the F/2 games and QB Holstein has thrown for 638 yds (67%, 6-2) while RB Reid has 293 yds (8.9). WVU is led by their 1-2 punch at RB with Donaldson/White and QB Greene is a dual-threat player with experience. WVU has a strong OL and they will face a Pitt pass rush that has collected 8 sks the F/2 gms. WVU HC Brown is 7-2 ATS vs non-conf foes since '22 but Pitt has pulled 17 outright upsets under Narduzzi and we think this game comes down to the wire.

MIAMI, FL by 45 over Ball St - First meeting. Ball St is 0-4 SU/ATS in road openers. The Cardinals are just 1-9 SU vs current ACC teams but are also 8-1-1 ATS in those games. Miami is 9-1 SU all-time vs MAC teams including a 38-3 (-16') win over Miami, OH in the opener last year. Miami enters 2-0 with wins over Florida & FAMU. Last week they were -48 and beat FAMU 56-9. The 'Canes did only have a 25-6 lead at half. Ball St actually had 207-68 yds & 14-2 FD edges at half last week vs Missouri St but was tied 7-7. The score was only 14-14 after 3Q then 48 points were scored in the 4th. Ball St had 10 total points in two games against P4 foes last year. Cristobal is just 15-30-2 as a HF including 2-10 here. Ball St has their MAC opener on deck will be happy to escape healthy so our lean is with Miami despite Cristobal's poor HF record.

OKLAHOMA by 13 over Tulane - Third meeting. Last meeting was in '21 in Norman. Oklahoma (-32) put up 23 straight after behind tied at 14 in the 1Q but gave up 3 td's in the 2H to only win 40-35. Last week Tulane played a ranked opponent vs #17 Kansas St (+8'), they were tied at 27 with 8:13 left but gave up a 60 yd fumble recovery TD then forced to punt and threw an INT with :12 to go. Oklahoma struggled at home last week as they couldn't get anything going on offense, outgained 318-252. OU (-27') scored off a muffed punt, 1 play 10 yds, then scored a TD early in the second quarter to pull out a 16-12 win vs Houston. Tulane HC Sumrall is 11-1 ATS on the road. Oklahoma is 47-10-1 all time vs AAC foes. Tulane has been playing with confidence and Oklahoma has a tough task with Tennessee on deck so we will go with the Wave to keep it close here.

MINNESOTA by 21 over Nevada - First meeting. Since 2004, Minnesota is 10-1 SU and 7-3-1 ATS vs the Mountain West. Last time playing at MWC foe was in '19 as a 3 pt fav won 38-35. Nevada fell to Iowa (+23) 27-0 in '22 but in '19 they did upset Purdue 34-31 as they had a +5 TO edge in the game. Minny is 15-9-1 ATS in non-conference games under HC PJ Fleck. Nevada last week (E) had chances to take the lead in the second half but failed to score on 5 of 6 possessions and fell to GA Southern 20-17. Minny came back from their week 1 loss to North Carolina, GW FG as time expired missed, with a dominate 48-0 (-24') win over Rhode Island. We will go with the Gophers to win by 3 tds here as their defense has looked very good TY (#4 in Pass Efficiency D).

Notre Dame by 14 over PURDUE - Notre Dame has won 8 straight over Purdue but are 4-4 ATS. Last met in '21, Purdue had the FD and yardage edge but it was not enough at they fell to the Irish 27-13. In '13 was their last meeting in West Lafayette, when ND (-18') won 31-24. Notre Dame is coming off their 2nd 20 + favorite SU loss in the last three years (Marshall -20', 21-26) as they loss to Northern Illinois as a 28 pt favorite. ND was outgained 388-286 and GW FG was blocked falling 16-14 at home. The Boilermakers have play 9 ranked foes in the last three years and have caused four outright upsets in those matchups. Coming off a SU loss in '23 the Irish were 3-0 ATS and as DD Favorite were 5-1 so we will go with Notre Dame to come back strong after last week.

EAST CAROLINA by 3 over Appalachian St - App St has won and covered both meetings as FBS foes in '21 and '23. LY (+7) ECU led 28-22 3Q but allowed 21 straight & lost 43-28. App St is off a 66-20 loss at Clemson where they trailed 56-13 HT (Clem 525-199 yd edge). ECU is off to a 2-0 start and are only allowing 201 ypg/9 ppg. The offense is putting up 486 ypg but QB Garcia has a 4-7 ratio, but App St's pass D just allowed 460 yards last week and ranks toward the bottom of the pass D rankings. App does have a SBC game on deck on a short week and HC Clark is just 3-11-1 ATS as an away favorite. ECU will have a good crowd on hand and we think they pick up the outright win here!

IOWA by 28 over Troy - First meeting. Troy's only win vs a Big 10 foe was the last time they face one in 2018 at Nebraska where they won 24-19 (+10). Iowa has not played a SBC foe since '11 and are 9-3 SU/7-5 ATS in non-conference play the last three ssns. Troy is 0-5 SU/1-4 ATS in their last 5 non-conf games a double-digit dog. Even though they Hawkeyes' are 50-17 at home since '14, they fell last week to Iowa St. Up 13-0 at half, scored with 4:47 to go up 19-7 but gave up a TD 11 sec's later then gave up a GW FG with :06 left to fall 20-19 at home vs Iowa St. Troy has struggled to stop the run giving up 214 and 211 this year. Last week they had their worst regular ssn offensive game since week 11 of '21, they had a total of 251 yds and fell to Memphis 38-17(+19). With Iowa coming off a home loss we expect them to win by 4 td's here.

ARKANSAS by 31 over Uab - Only prior meeting was back in '14 when UAB fell 45-17 (+26'). Both teams come off a loss but Arkansas was far more impressive last week. Ark had a 351-77 yard edge at half at OKSt but a pick-6 kept the Cowboys in the game. Ark ran out of gas in the second half and lost 39-31 in OT. UAB was -11 at ULM last week and put up just 259 yards in a 32-6 loss though they were only -37 yds for the game and -3 TO's. Bobby Petrino has made an immediate impact on Arkansas' offense, putting up 668 ypg in their first two games and Boise St transfer Taylen Green has thrown for 645 (62%, 3-1) and rushed for 149. UAB is 0-6 SU/1-5 ATS vs the SEC since '17. Arkansas does have their SEC opener on deck and Pittman isn't great as a home favorite but we don't think the Hogs hold back coming off a loss. We will take Bobby Petrino's offense against a DC that was coaching at a HS two years ago.

Utah by 24 over UTAH ST - 113th meeting of the Battle of the Brothers. Last met in 2015 where Utah (-12) won 24-14. Last met here in 2012 and Utah St (+7) pulled the outright upset 27-20. Utah is off to a 2-0 start and last week beat Baylor 23-12 but 153 of their 292 yards came on their F/4 drives (Utah up 17-0) but QB Rising hurt his hand and missed 2H (check status). Utah St is off a 48-0 loss at USC where they were outgained 544-190 where QB Barnes (former Utah QB) got the start and he could start here vs his old team. Since 2021 Utah is just 3-9 ATS as an away favorite and they have a huge game at Okla St on deck, but this USU team looks like they are going to struggle and Utah will look to get revenge on their old QB.

Virginia Tech by 10 over OLD DOMINION - Both of ODU's wins vs P4 teams have come against VT here at home. ODU is off to an 0-2 start, but both losses are by one score including a 4 point loss at S.Car in Week 1 where they had the yds edge but were -3 TO's. VT was upset at Vandy in Week 1 and last week got on track with a 31-14 win vs Marshall. VT's OL has been a bit of an issue early on as they have allowed 8 sks in 2 games and the ODU pass rush has 7 sacks in 2 games. ODU was 3-0 ATS as a home dog last season including 2 outright upsets, but their offense has struggled early (296 ypg) and the OL has all's 9 sks. VT has a non-conf game vs Rutgers on deck and they will have a good number of fans here, but given the series history (Home team 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS) we will call for ODU to keep this game within the line.

LIBERTY by 17 over Utep - UTEP makes their first trip to Lynchburg, VA. Last year the Miners hosted Liberty in the season finale. Liberty had the CUSA Title game on deck and held a 469-271 yard edge. They were -17' and led 42-14 but allowed two td's in the final 3:32 for a misleading 14 point win. The Flames are now 0-8 ATS as a favorite of 20+ points yet once again are laying over 3 td's. In week 1 they were -39 and only won by 17 then last week they were -22' at NMST and trailed 24-15 4Q but scored two late td's and won by 6. UTEP is 0-2 with losses to Nebraska and FCS' Southern Utah last week. Liberty has a big coaching edge but we can't take the Flames laying over 3 td's and their near loss last week came against a NMST team that also nearly lost to an FCS school the week prior.

DUKE by 20 over UConn - These two just met last year and Duke won 41-7 (-22). The home team is 0-3 ATS in this series. Duke enters 2-0 in Manny Diaz' first year. They were fortunate to beat Northwestern last week, pulling the game out in OT. UConn is 1-1 after losing at Maryland 50-7 but they rebounded with a 63-17 (-14') win over Merrimack last week. QB Joe Fagnano started in place of injured Nick Evers and threw for 328 yards and 5 td's. Duke is 29-2 SU/25-6 ATS vs Non-Power 4 foes including 20-0 SU/17-3 ATS at home but Manny Diaz is just 7-11 as a home favorite. This is a must win for Duke's bowl hopes with Middle Tennessee on deck then a tough ACC schedule. The angles say to take Duke so we will make this our Technical POW.

FAU by 3 over Fiu - FAU is 16-5 in the Shula bowl including 6 straight SU/ATS wins with an avg margin of victory of 32.3. This is the first non-conference meeting between the teams since 2004. Last time met in '22, FAU (-15') were +4 in TOs and had the +108 yd edge winning 52-7. As a road dog FIU was 4-2 LY and in wk 2 (+23') were shut out in the second half and gave up a late 4Q td to fall 31-7. Last week the Panthers were +6 in TOs and put up 39 points of them to beat Central Michigan (+5') 52-16. FAU kept it close in their opener to Michigan St (+13') falling 16-10 but last week they couldn't defend the triple option as they gave 405 on the ground and fell 24-7 (4★ LP winner under 43). FAU is coming off a brutal loss & this is an in-state rivalry so we feel like while the Owls will win, the Panthers will be able to cover the spread.

Ole Miss by 21 over WAKE FOREST - Ole Miss last played here in '08 with WF pulling out a 30-28 win. The Rebels have yet to give up a td in their first two games. Jaxson Dart broke Tee Martin's SEC record for consecutive completions after hitting on his first 24 passes. The Rebels beat Middle Tenn 52-3 (-43). WF let a 13 point 4Q lead slip away last week and lost to Virginia. QB Hank Bachmeier threw for 403 yards and has a 4-0 ratio. Ole Miss had a misleading win in last year's road opener at Tulane when they trailed at half and were tied 17-17 4Q but won by 17 and Tulane was missing QB Pratt. WF hasn't been a double-digit home non-conf dog since '12 and Ole Miss hasn't been a 3 td road favorite in non-conference play since 2001. Dave Clawson is 9-4 ATS when his team is a dog of 3+ td's and we like the WF offense to try to keep up with Ole Miss in a high scoring game.

Wku by 14 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - It's the 100 Miles of Hate Rivalry. Middle Tenn HC Derek Mason has gotten off to a rough start. They nearly lost to a below average FCS team in Tenn Tech then were crushed at Ole Miss 52-3 (+43) last week. WKU was dominated in week 1 by Bama but bounced back for a 31-0 (-20') win over Eastern Kentucky. LSU/Auburn/Texas St transfer QB TJ Finley threw for 351 yards and 1 td. WKU has won 9 of the last 12 meetings including five straight and they've covered the last three. Last year WKU was only -6.5 and led 23-3 at half, finishing with a 31-10 win. WKU has the experience edge and the better offense and defense. They've controlled the series and will be fired up to beat a rival in their CUSA opener.

Jacksonville St by 3 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - Last year these two met for the first time and Jax St won 21-0 with a 388-152 yard edge. Rich Rodriguez returns to the state of Michigan. His Gamecocks is off two blow out losses to Coastal Carolina and Louisville. They've allowed 581 ypg including 318 pass ypg (66%) and 264 rush (5.7). Things haven't been much better on offense. Furman transfer QB Tyler Huff has a 2-3 ratio and is their leading rusher with 112 (4.9). EMich played an impressive first quarter at Washington last week and covered as a 2★ Power Sweep play. The Eagles are not in their preferred role here, opening as a small home favorite. It's hard to trust either team here but we do think Rich Rod will right the ship for Jax St and call for a small upset.

Vanderbilt by 20 over GEORGIA ST - First meeting. Vandy is looking to start 3-0 for the first time since 2017 and are led by transfer QB Pavia who is also leading the team in rushing as well. GSt lost at GTech in the opener and last week needed a 4Q td to pull ahead and win vs FCS Chattanooga 24-21. The Pathers ranked only #113 in experience entering '24 and have a first-time HC with a ton of brand new players. QB Veilleux (Pitt transfer) is hitting 63% (3-0 ratio) and the offense has avg'd 376 yds the F/2 gms. GSt doesn't have much of a home crowd and this Vandy teams seems to rally around QB Pavia who is a tough minded QB and they have momentum going into this game and are facing a GSt team who is in a clear rebuild. This is the first time since 2013 that Vandy is a DD favorite on the road, but even in this unfamiliar role we like the 'Dores to take care of business by almost 3 td's.

SOUTH CAROLINA over Lsu

SOUTH CAROLINA over Lsu - Hard to believe this is SC's first trip to Columbia since '08 when LSU won 24-17. LSU has been unimpressive in their first two games, losing to USC then last week only led 23-21 3Q before scoring 3 td's and won 45-21 (-45'). SC was unimpressive in their come-from-behind win over ODU in week 1 but looked much better last week, dominating KY 31-6 (+9') and were one of three outright winners on our Big Dogs (Just \$15, call 1-800-654-3448). The Gamecocks held a 252-183 yard edge. LaNorris Sellers threw 2 td passes in his 2nd start. Shane Beamer is 4-4 as a home dog at South Carolina with 4 outright upsets by 19.2 ppg. LSU QB Garrett Nussmeier does have an 8-1 ratio but this is his first true road start. LSU has 0 sacks in two games while South Carolina has 10 sacks, led by Kyle Kennard (3.5) and true frosh Dylan Stewart (2.5). LSU has the edge on offense but SC has the edge on defense and ST's edge. LSU is a 7 point favorite here but we like the Gamecocks to get us our 3rd outright upset in as many weeks for our Underdog POW!!!

TEXAS by 31 over Utsa - UTSA played here in '22 and the game was actually tied 17-17 at half but the Roadrunners lost 41-20 (+12'). Texas is coming off their dominant 31-12 win over Michigan where they held a 389-284 yard edge and cashed a 2H Power Sweep Play for us. They only have ULM on deck. UTSA suffered their worst loss in the Jeff Traylor era, losing 49-10 (+1'). The Roadrunners are 0-6 SU/2-4 ATS vs ranked teams under Traylor and are on a 0-4 run as away dogs. Texas has won 48 straight vs current G5 teams (32-17-1 ATS) but are laying nearly five td's here. Sark is using ND's loss last week to keep his players from letting up but they have failed to cover their last 3 when favored by over 30 so our lean is with the underdog.

SAM HOUSTON ST by 3 over Hawaii - First meeting. Since '18 UH is just 1-9 SU/3-7 ATS in non-conf road regular season games and this is their first trip to Texas since 2014. UH is off a bye week and in their last game 2 weeks ago they led UCLA 10-0 HT (178-94 yd edge) but lost 16-13 on a late FG. SHSt is off a 45-14 loss at UCF where the Bearkats allowed 554 yds and were -17 FD's. SHSt allowed 7 sks in the opener and in their last game UH's OL gave up 5 sacks and the offense only put up 331 in the opener vs a poor FCS team. Hawaii is the more experienced team and are in year 3 under HC Chang, but do have to travel far here and SHSt is also exp'd and has a solid home edge. These teams appear evenly matched and we'll call for this game at the line.

Usf by 7 over SOUTHERN MISS - First meeting since 2004 and Southern Miss have won 3 of the 4 meetings. USF has won 8 straight versus SBC foes but have not faced one since '10. Southern Miss played Tulane last ssn, the Eagles (+11') were -112 net yds and fell 21-3. In '22 they were a 12' pt dog at Tulane and pulled off the 27-24 road upset. Last week USF (+30') was only down 21-16 with 6:45 left in the game but gave up three straight td drives, 3/75 2/60 1/29, to lose in misleading fashion 42-16. Southern Miss put up their worst offensive game since '21 in week one getting shut out 31-0 and held to 131 yds but did hold Kentucky to 317 yds. LW (-15') the defense held SE Louisiana to 274 yards in a 35-10 win. USF is off Bama and has Miami, FI at home next week so they need a win here but we expect the Golden Eagles to keep it close.

AUBURN by 35 over New Mexico - First meeting. The Lobos are 0-2 in their first year under Bronco Mendenhall. The offense has put up 80 total points in their two losses but they've allowed 48 ppg and 597 ypg. Their rush D is allowing 284 (7.8) and face Auburn's Jarquez Hunter who has 121 (7.6). Aub comes in off a home loss to California, 21-14 (-12). Peyton Thorne threw for 322 yards and 4 td's in the opener but had just 164 and 4 int's last week. Thorne should get back on track against a NM pass D that allowed 422 yards last week. Auburn is 7-3 ATS when favored by 28+ points and the Over has cashed in the last six when Auburn is -28+. We think Auburn wins handily and with NM's poor defense the Over could be in the mix for our Sept Totals GOM!

BAYLOR by 21 over Air Force - Last met in the 2022 bowl game where AF (+3') won 30-15 as they ran for 276 (4.1) and held Baylor to 230 total yards. AF's offense lost 9 starters incl their top 3 rushers and all 5 OL, and as a result they are struggling to run the ball (155, 3.1) through 2 gms and could not get anything going against San Jose St last week. Baylor's HC Aranda is a great defensive coach and has seen the option, plus their defense held a good Utah team to 292 yds. Baylor has an exp'd team back (#25) and are led by transfer QB Finn and Baylor will want to get their new-look spread offense going before B12 play starts next week. Calhoun is a solid 12-5-1 ATS as a road dog since '15, but they just lost so much production from LY's team that it will take some time for the Falcons to get their option going. Give us the Bears at home by 3 td's.

TCU by 7 over Ucf - First meeting. Both teams enter their B12 opener 2-0 as UCF has 57-3 and 45-14 wins under their belt while TCU came back to beat Stanford 34-27 in the opener and LW shutout an FCS team 45-0. Both defenses have played well early as TCU held Stanford to 281 while UCF held Sam Houston to just 286 yds. TCU QB Hoover is hitting 72% with a 4-0 ratio and they have one of the top WR's in CFB, Savion Williams, but have a deep WR room. UCF brought in former Ark QB KJ Jefferson, but UCF faces a TCU defense that has 9 starters back. TCU is 11-3 SU/10-4 ATS in home games under HC Dykes and with this line near a pick'em, all they have to do is win and UCF allowed 486 ypg/35 ppg in B12 road games LY. We have a feeling this could be a high-scoring game, but side with the Horned Frogs by a td.

Georgia by 35 over KENTUCKY - UGA has won the last 14 series meetings. The Dawgs covered six straight from '13-'18 then KY covered four straight from '19-'22 until UGA won 51-13 (-14') last year. KY's offense was dreadful last week in a 31-6 loss to Kentucky. UGA transfer QB Brock Vandagriff completed just 3 of 10 passes for 30 yards and 1 int. Rutgers transfer Gavin Wimsatt was no better, completing 3 of 7 for 14 yards and 1 int. Now they face Georgia's D who held Clemson to 188 yards and 3 points in week 1. It's worth noting that Clemson rebounded the following week with 66 points and 712 yards against App State. Kirby Smart is 20-11 ATS as an away favorite. We won our Sept Totals GOM on the Under in this game back in '21. We have a hard time seeing how Kentucky scores in this game so it's right back in the mix for this year's Totals GOM!

Colorado by 3 over COLORADO ST - 90th meeting of the Rocky Mountain Showdown. This is CSU's first time hosting Colorado since 1996! Last season CSU led 21-14 HT with a 262-85 yd edge! But Colo got a td pass when :36 left 4Q to tie the game and the Buffs won it 2OT (CSU 499-418 yd edge). After getting shutout in the opener, CSU put up 426 yds in a 38-17 win last week vs FCS N.Colo. QB Fowler-Nicolosi made his 1st career start vs Colo LY (367 yds but 3 int) but star WR Horton was banged up last week (check status). Colo's OL problems showed up again last week as the Buffs ran for just 16 yards (0.7 ypc) and allowed 6 sacks. The Buffs pass D is allowing 76.8% completions! The Rams will want revenge for letting LY's game slip away and we think the Rams pass attack will keep them in this, but CU QB Sanders and dynamic playmaker Travis Hunter will make just enough plays for the Buffs to escape with a close win.

TENNESSEE by 56 over Kent St - First meeting. Tennessee hosted another subpar MAC team in '22 when they won 63-6 (-47'). The Vols scored their final td with under a minute left in that game as Josh Heupel runs his offense until the final play. Kent St has covered 3 of their last 4 vs the SEC including a 28-6 loss at Arkansas as a 48 point dog last year. Tenn is coming off an impressive win over NCSt and they've yet to allow an offensive td this year. They held the Wolfpack to 143 yards and just 1.4 ypc. The Vols are now 13-5 as a home favorite under Heupel and the Over is 11-3 when Vols are favored by 19 points or more. Kent St comes in off a surprising loss to FCS St Francis who had just lost to a non-scholarship Dayton team. Kent St also put up just 212 yards and lost by 31 at Pitt in week 1. This one will get out of hand fast and the Vols are one of very few teams we don't mind laying 7 td's with.

HOUSTON by 3 over Rice - Houston leads this series 33-12. Rice had lost 7 straight but last week they pulled off the upset. The Owls (+8) were up 28-7 and had the 326-92 yd edge but in the 2H they were outgained 307-102. The Cougars climbed back with 21 unanswered pts to force OT but failed to convert a 2-point conversion losing 43-41. In their ssn opener, Rice (-9) couldn't get their offense going as QB EJ Warner threw two picks in a home loss to Sam Houston but last week they put up 533 and held TX Southern to 87 yds in a 69-7 win. Last week Houston (-27') did have the yardage edge (318-249) against Oklahoma but after opening up the 2H with a TD they punted twice, Safety, INT and TOD in their next possessions falling 16-12. Houston is playing for revenge from last year so we are not calling for the outright upset but we expect Rice to keep it close for these in-state rivals.

Maryland by 6 over VIRGINIA - These two were once ACC rivals but now meet as non-conference foes. Last year they met and UVA led 14-0 then MD scored the final 42 points. These two were on the opposite ends of blown 4th quarter leads last week. Maryland was -8' and led Michigan St 24-17 then missed a fg to go up 10 with just 4:22 left and MSU threw a 77 yard td pass, forced a punt then won 27-24. UVA trailed WF by 30-17 4Q but Tony Elliott's squad rallied to score td's with 10:37 and 2:07 left. UVA's D allowed 403 pass yards and faces MD's Billy Edwards who is hitting 75% with a 4-1 ratio for 564 yards. We think there is some value on Maryland after the blown lead and UVA's come-from-behind win from last week. MD is 4-1 SU/ATS in the last 3 years when favored by 3 points or less and we like the Terps to bounce back off a loss.

Byu by 3 over WYOMING - Will be the 80th meeting for these former MW foes. BYU is 2-0 this season and are off a road win at SMU where they held the Mustangs to 261 yds. WY on the other hand is 0-2 and just lost to FCS Idaho a week ago at home. However, BYU's top 2 RB's are doubtful for this game. WY has been without top RB Waylee for the F/2 games and will likely miss here. WY will need QB Svoboda to step up and get the pass game going. WY does have a strong defense with 7 starters back led by LB Suiaunoa. WY is a tough place to play, especially at night. Since 2016 WY is 7-2 ATS as a DD home dog with 5 outright upsets incl one of Texas Tech last season. BYU is just 1-3 ATS since 2019 as a DD road favorite and we like WY to rally and keep this game close.

FRESNO ST by 14 over New Mexico St - Fresno St is 19-1 SU in this series and actually met in the New Mexico Bowl last year with Fresno winning 37-10 and had a 500-200 yard edge. Going into the 4Q of that game it was only 20-10. That game was actually Fresno St's first under current HC Tim Skipper. NMSSt was unimpressive in the opener but nearly upset Liberty as 22' pt dogs last week. The Aggies led 24-15 4Q but allowed 27 & 44 yard td runs in the last six minutes and lost 30-24. Fresno St played Michigan tougher than the final score in week 1 then last week led Sac St 46-23 4Q before a late td. Expect NMSSt to lean on 220 lb RB Seth McGown who started his career at Oklahoma and has a 5.9 ypc in their first two games. Sanchez is 17-10 ATS as away dogs and we think they run the ball to shorten the game and keep it closer than last year.

CALIFORNIA by 21 over San Diego St - 9th meeting. Last met in 2016 in San Diego and the Aztecs won a high-scoring game 45-40. SDSSt only put up 179 yds last week in a 21-0 loss vs Oreg St and they struggled early with Tex A&M-Commerce in the opener, as they trailed 6-3 HT. Cal is off an outright upset win at Auburn where they held the Tigers to 286 yds and were +5 TO's and scored twice off those TO's. SDSSt QB O'Neil is only hitting 58% and has 321 pass yds in 2 games. Cal has a strong pass defense and they defend the run well led by LB Uluave. Cal has the #11 pass D while SDSSt is down at #107. Cal QB Mendoza played well last week (233, 69%, 2-0 ratio). Cal is off a huge win and have the ACC opener at Florida St on deck, but SDSSt is struggling to move the ball and now face a strong Cal team, plus Cal HC Wilcox is 5-3 ATS since '22 as home chalk after being 3-11-1 ATS in his F/5 ssn's here. Give us Cal by 3 scores!

SAN JOSE ST by 21 over Kennesaw St - First meeting. KSU is making their first trip ever to the state of California. SJSSt had a misleading final in their season opener when they came from behind in the 2H to beat Sac St 42-24. Last week they shut down Air Force's option in a 17-7 win and had a 312-197 yard edge. KSU is -207 ypg after a 12 point loss to UTSA and 24 point home loss to Louisiana. The Owls run a variation of the Pistol option and SJSSt's run D was dominant last week, holding AF to 143 rush (3.1). SJSSt is 20 point favorites at press time which is a slight lean to the home Spartans but it's tough to lay almost 3 td's with this young team coming off an upset win.

QB Burrow only threw for 164 and CIN only ran for 70 yds. KC WR Rice topped 100 yds LW and rookie WR Worthy recorded 2 td's LW. CIN is 6-3-1 ATS s/22 as a road dog but KC is on an 11-4 ATS run in conference games. CIN won't have #2 WR Higgins here and their offense could struggle to keep up with KC as QB Burrow looks to get back to his old form off an injury and was showing signs of rust last week. We'll take KC in Arrowhead by 2 td's. **FORECAST: Kansas City by 14**
3★ LA Rams over ARIZONA - The Rams have owned this series of late as they are 13-2 SU/ATS since 2017 with those 13 wins coming by an avg of 18 ppg and all 13 wins are by at least 7 pts. LAR is off a 26-20 OT loss at DET where they lost WR Nacua to a knee inj & he will miss here. WR Kuppp stepped up (14 rec, 110 yds, 1 td) but LAR will need more from RB Williams. ARZ scored on all 3 of their drives in the 1H and led 17-10 HT but all'd BUF to score on 4 of 6 drives in 2H and lost 34-28. LAR QB Stafford threw for 229 yds & 4 td here LY. ARZ QB Murray is 1-7 SU/ATS vs LAR with an 8-6 ratio. LAR also has the huge coaching edge here. We expect the Rams to come out dialed up and think their domination over ARZ continues here and they are a slight dog as of presstime. **FORECAST: LA Rams by 7**

2★ Tampa Bay (+) over DETROIT - Rematch of the '23 Divisional Round playoff game where DET got a late INT to seal a 31-23 win. These teams also met in the reg ssn LY and DET won 20-6 in Tampa. Both teams got off to a 1-0 start as DET won 26-20 in OT vs LAR while TB QB Mayfield threw for 289 & 4 td in a 37-20 win vs WAS (4★ LP winner on TB!). DET has a strong 1-2 punch at RB (131 yds in Wk 1) but TB's run D held teams to 93 ypg LY and held DET to 40 rush yds in the reg ssn LY. DET's pass D has all'd 300+ yds in 6 of the L77 gms dating back to LY (all'd 317 LW) now faces a good pass attack & LY in the playoffs TB QB Mayfield threw for 349 yds vs DET. OTHER PLAYS

Buffalo vs MIAMI - Thursday - Dating back to 2019 BUF is 10-1 SU (6-5 ATS) against MIA and their avg MOV is 15 pts. Last season BUF was 2-0 SU/ATS vs MIA and in their trip here had a 473-275 yd edge in a 21-14 win. Both teams are off comeback wins as MIA trailed 17-7 at HT vs JAX while BUF trailed ARZ 17-10 before coming back to win 34-28 (3★ LP winner on Over 46!) behind QB Allen's 4 total td's. MIA was just 1-5 SU/ATS against playoff teams LY with all 5 losses by at least a td. MIA avg'd 28 ppg LY but in 2 gms vs BUF avg'd just 17 pts. MIA's strong pass attack (319 yds LW) will test BUF's new-look secondary and MIA is 10-5 ATS as a HF s/22. **Call the office on Thursday after Noon EST for the Marquee Winner!**

BALTIMORE by 13 over Las Vegas - First meeting since '21 and first trip to BAL since 2018 when the Raiders were in Oakland. Both teams enter 0-1 as BAL was a toe away from potentially upsetting KC in Arrowhead while LV was held to 296 yds and were -3 TO's in a 22-10 loss at LAC. The Raiders, who allowed 176 rush ypg (6.5) LW, could be in trouble here vs a potent BAL rush attack (#1 NFL LY, 156 ypg) that ran for 185 (5.8) LW led by QB Jackson (122, 7.6) and BAL also has RB Henry. BAL also had TE Likely emerge LW (9 rec, 111 yds, 1 td). BAL was 3-0 ATS off a SU loss LY and 9-4 ATS as a single-digit favorite LY and LV is traveling cross country for a 1 pm kick. We like BAL to bounce back with a convincing win.

LA Chargers by 3 over CAROLINA - Teams last met in '20 when CAR (+6) went to LAC and pulled the outright upset 21-16. CAR is off a rough opening loss to NOLA where they all'd the Saints to score on their F/9 drives in a 47-10 game wher CAR managed just 193 yds & QB Young was just 13-30 passing. CAR did lose Pro Bowl DT Derrick Brown for the season (knee). LAC is off an opening week 22-10 win in LV where they ran for 176 yds (6.5) but QB Herbert only threw for 144 yds. While CAR was just 1-4 ATS vs the AFC LY, LAC is traveling cross country after a big DIV win and their pass game is still a work in progress. We'll cut off our lean on LAC at a FG.
DALLAS by 10 over New Orleans - DAL opened the '24 season with a 33-17 win at CLE, but the yds were close (265-230) but DAL was +2 TO's and got a PR TD. DAL all-pro WR Lamb could have a big day if NOLA CB Lattimore (hamstring) misses this gm (check status). NOLA thrashed CAR last week 47-10, but face a much tougher Cowboys D here that collected 6 sacks in Week 1. NOLA was just 1-4-1 ATS LY vs playoff teams and DAL was +117 ypg/+18 ppg at home LY and are 11-4 ATS as a HF since '22. NOLA looked good week 1, but QB Carr will be under more pressure here and WR Olave could struggle vs a good DAL secondary. We'll take the Cowboys to get a DD win in the home opener at Jerry World!

Indianapolis by 3 over GREEN BAY - The biggest news going into this game is that GB QB Love will be out and the Packers backup Malik Willis will get the start here. He started 3 gms in '22 with TEN and had 276 pass yds (51%) with a 0-3 ratio. GB does have a talented WR room and we expect new RB Jacobs to get a lot of work and faces a Colts run D that allowed 213 yds (5.3) last week. IND only managed 303 yds on offense LW and QB Richardson was only 9-19 passing, but GB did allow Philly to gain 410 yds. IND was 3-0 ATS as a road dog LY, but GB is 4-2 ATS as a HD since '21 and even with the downgrade at QB for GB, we still think they keep this game close & we'll call for it to finish right at the line.

JACKSONVILLE by 9 over Cleveland - Both teams are off to an 0-1 start. JAX led MIA 17-7 HT and were going to go up 24-7 but an Etienne fumble at the goal line swung momentum & JAX lost on a last sec FG 20-17. CLE trailed 20-3 HT, all'd a punt ret td 2H and only gained 230 yds with 112 yds coming in their L/2 drives. CLE has covered just 1 of L/5 vs JAX. JAX was 4-2 ATS as a HF last ssn and 7-3 ATS LY as a single-digit favorite. CLE was just 2-6-1 ATS on the road LY. QB Watson struggled LW and CLE struggled to block and develop a run game. CLE's DEF all'd 31 ppg on the road LY and JAX QB Lawrence is back healthy and has a great cast of skill players. JAX also held a much better offensive team to 20 pts LW. We'll take JAX here by over a 2.

San Francisco by 3 over MINNESOTA - These teams met here just LY on Mon Night and MIN (+7) outgained SF 452-325 in a 22-17 win. MIN went to NYG last week and won easily 28-6 while only putting up 312 yds (pick-six 4Q). New QB Darnold was efficient (19-24 for 201) and the OL only allowed 1 sack. WR Addison had a big game LY vs SF (7 rec, 123 yds, 2 td) and now WR Jefferson is healthy as well (DNP LY). The Vikings D held NYG to 220 yds, and this MIN defense gave QB Purdy fits LY as he threw 2 int's. SF could again be w/o star RB McCaffrey and backup RB Mason (147, 5.3) won't surprise anyone this week. While SF was 6-2-1 ATS as a road favorite LY, the Vikings are playing with confidence and now are at home with SF traveling on short rest perhaps down their top offensive player. We like MIN to keep it close and possibly pull the upset.

WAS rookie QB Daniels was solid in his debut, passing for 184 & running for 88 yds & 2 td. However the WAS defense gave up 280 pass yds (80% compl) and 4 td's.
