4★ CINCINNATI over Houston - Cincy has won the last 4 meetings both SU & ATS. Last year Cincy (+3) pulled the outright upset with a 24-14 road win. CIN delivered a 4★ Power Sweep winner (5-1 record last week!) with a 27-16 win over Miami, OH last week where CIN ran for 215 (6.3). HOU picked up their first win in the Willie Fritz era, beating Rice 33-7 as they held Rice to 159 yards and 9 FD's and ran for 237 (5.6). Cincy has the huge edge on offense (#30 vs #83) and ST's (#14 vs #76) plus HOU's OL has allowed 10 sks in 3 gms while the Bearcats pass rush has 8 sks in 3 gms. Cincy is a blown 4Q lead vs Pitt from being 3-0, while HOU is only putting up 319 ypg overall. CIN's lone B12 win LY came vs HOU and this Bearcats team is better while HOU lost a lot and CIN is laying under a td at home, so we'll go back to the Bearcats for our top Newsletter play!

FORECAST: CINCINNATI by 17

3★ BOSTON COLLEGE over Michigan St - This is BC's Red Bandanna game which honors 9/11 hero Welles Crowther. Last year in BC's Red Bandanna game they were +25 and only lost 31-29 against #5 Florida St. Last week at Missouri, BC was +14 but led 14-3 early 2Q. They allowed the next 24 points but were never behind the spread and only lost 27-21. MSU is 3-0 but could easily have two losses after escaping against FAU and Maryland. Two weeks ago they were down 7 with under 5 minutes to go at MD and the Terps missed a fg. MSU answered with a 77 yd td pass then a fg on their final play to pull the upset. QB Aidan Chiles has thrown 5 int's and faces BC's #17 ranked pass D that only allows 55% and a 2-3 ratio. Bill O'Brien is 8-1 ATS off a SU loss and after losing their last two Red Bandanna games we have the Eagles with a comfortable win against a team with a misleading 3-0 record.

FORECAST: BOSTON COLLEGE by 14

3★ OREGON ST over Purdue - Third meeting. This year's game will be the first matchup in Corvallis. Last met in '21, Purdue (-7) had the 23-21 4Q lead and scored with 2:09 left to seal the game 30-21. The Boilermakers are 3-6 ATS in non-conf play the last years including last week vs Notre Dame. Purdue (+7) had their worst offensive game since '19, when they put 162 yds of offense and lost 66-7 which marked their worst defeat in school history. OSU(+17) held it close going into half 22-14 but were shutout in the 2H and gave up scoring drives on all 6 possessions the Ducks had losing 49-14. Purdue were just 1-4 ATS coming off a SU loss last year. Since '21, OSU is 17-4 SU/ATS at home, the line is under a TD so we will go with the Beavers to win by 2 td's!

FORECAST: OREGON ST by 16

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Georgia Tech (+) over LOUISVILLE - These two met in the opener last year. UL was -7 but GT led 28-13 at half. UL scored the first 26 points in the 2H before GT went 75/7 to cut it to 39-34 with 1:07 left. Brent Key is 5-0 SU/ATS vs ranked ACC foes and UL is ranked #19 in this week's AP Poll. The Jackets are off a 59-7 beating over VMI. Haynes King has thrown for 962, completing 76% with a 6-1 ratio and 148 rush (5.7). UL is fresh off a bye and their wins were only against Austin Peay and Jax St. UL is 10-4 as an ACC home favorite since '20 but GT is 8-3 as an ACC road dog since '21. GT is more battle tested and more experienced. Key has proven he gets his teams up to play their ranked foes and the Jackets are getting double-digits here so we have a nice lean on the underdog.

FORECAST: LOUISVILLE by 3

2★ East Carolina over LIBERTY - First meeting. Despite Liberty being 3-0 SU on the year they have failed to cover each game and have struggled against New Mexico St and UTEP. East Carolina is 9-3 ATS vs non-conference foes including 2-1 this year. The Pirates coming off a tough loss to SBC fav App St. The Pirates (+1) led 16-0 after a Pick-6. App St led 21-16, EC went 50/12 fg then down 2 QB Garcia was intercepted on their final drive. East Carolina is 10-4 ATS as an Away Dog since '21 including in wk 2 (+1) win at Old Dominion. Liberty HC Chadwell is 13-17 ATS as a home favorite. Liberty's top rusher, Quinton Cooley is ? for this game and EC has a stout run D, allowing just 73 rush ypg (2.1). Liberty has been unimpressive in all 3 games, even trailing New Mex St late 4Q. EC has played a tougher sked and we think they are primed to pull an upset.

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 19TH

South Alabama at APPALACHIAN ST - This is the SBC opener for both teams. App St is 4-1 SU vs SAla, winning the L/4, but the home team is on a 4-1 ATS run. Last met in '21 with App St (-22) winning 31-7. SAla got their first win of the season last week, as they scored 87 points and gained 620 yards. QB Lopez was back last week, and in 2 starts this season has 689 yds (60%) with a 7-0 ratio. App St trailed ECU 16-0 1H and 16-14 HT but took a 21-16 lead 3Q and held on to win. App St did put up 505 yds incl 424 pass from QB Aguilar. App St does have 7 sks on the season but SAla's OL has all'd just 3 sks in 3 gms. App St is just 2-5 ATS as a +7 point favorite in SBC play since 2022, but this is the first time since '21 SAla is a dog of at least 7 pts in a Sun Belt game.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 20TH

SYRACUSE by 13 over Stanford - Stanford is traveling 2,100 miles for their ACC debut. The Cardinal have actually won their last six vs the ACC (4-1-1 ATS) since 2010. Both teams enter fresh off a bye. Cuse enters 2-0 for the 3rd straight year. The Orange offense has looked potent in their first 2 games, putting up 38 pts and 354 yards vs Ohio then 31 pts and 515 yards vs GTech. Ohio St transfer Kyle McCord has thrown for 735 yards (69%, 8-1). Stanford allowed 353 pass yards in the opener against TCU, a misleading 7 point loss and their only win was against Cal Poly who went 3-8 at the FCS level last year. Cuse is 8-4-1 ATS as a HF while Stanford is 7-16 as an away dog since '17. Cuse only has Holy Cross on deck and should have a good crowd on hand for a Friday night game on national tv so we like the Orange by nearly 2 td's.

NEBRASKA by 10 Illinois - Nebraska joined the B10 in '13 and started the conf series going 6-1 SU but have dropped the last 3 of 4 since. Last time met in Lincoln ('22), Illinois (-7) was down 9-6 early in the 2Q but scored 20 unanswered pts to win 26-9. Last year Nebraska (+3) held the Illini to their lowest rush yd tfl since '19, 21 rush yds on 19 carries (1.1 ypc), and won their only road game of the year 20-7. This is the first road game of '24 for Illinois were they have been 11-3 ATS the last 3 years. The under is 8-3 in the series and both teams rank inside our top 20 for Pass D Efficiency (Neb #6-ILL #16). Both QB's in this matchup have been solid as Neb QB has a 5-1 and Illinois QB has 6-0 ratio but look out for the defenses in this matchup. Nebraska has been all around better than their 5-7 record show last year so we will go with the Huskers to win by 10!

WASHINGTON ST by 10 over San Jose St - Last time these teams met was in '18 where WSU won 31-0 (the last WSU shutout) with a 544-124 yd edge. WSU is 3-0, but have been outgained by 75 and 71 yds the last 2 games and are allowing 464 ypg on the season. WSU QB Mateer is the Cougars leading rusher (314, 8.1) but is only hitting 53%. SJSt has struggled to run the ball this season (58, 1.9) but QB Emmett Brown has topped 300 yds in 2 of the Spartans games already (915, 61%, 9-2) and WR Nash has been his #1 target with 34 catches & 485 yds (17 rec last week!) in 3 games. WSU is 10-5 ATS at home under HC Dickert, but they are off a big rivalry win and has a key matchup with Boise St on deck. SJSt has played a weak schedule (#121) but have outgained all 3 foes and we see them covering the spread, which is over 2 td's.

COLLEGE MARQUEES!!!!!!

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SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 21ST

Virginia by 1 over COSTAL CAROLINA - First meeting. This is the first time since 2011 that UVA has been a non-conf AF and they won 34-31 at Indiana but did not cover (-7). Coastal is 3-0 on the season, but only beat Temple 28-20 last week & were held to 287 yds after putting up 450+ in each of the first 2 gms. CC is rushing for 252 ypg (5.2) and has allowed just 1 sack. UVA is 2-1 but 2 weeks ago trailed Wake 30-17 4Q before coming back to win and last week were -4 TO's in a 27-13 loss to Maryland. This is only the 2nd time CC has hosted a P4 foe (hosted Kansas in '21, won 49-22). Since 2020 Coastal is 6-1 SU/ATS as a home underdog including 2 outright home upsets last season. Coastal has a good home field edge, but UVA has some playmakers to go along with QB Colandrea and with a tough ACC slate coming up, UVA needs this win for their bowl hopes later on in the season. We see a close game here with UVA winning by a point.

PENN ST by 52 over Kent St - Sixth meeting since '03. Penn St is 5-0 SU and 3-2 ATS with an avg MOV by 28 ppg. Last mtg was in '18. Kent St (+35) only trailed PSU 21-10 at half but gave up 5 unanswered td's in 6 possession in the 2H to fall 63-10. Since '00, Kent is 0-19 SU/5-14 ATS vs B10 foes and TY they are 0-3 SU/ATS. Last week they gave up 740 yds and 71 points against Tenn. Penn St is on a 13-0 SU/ 9-4 ATS vs the MAC incl. two wks ago vs Bowling Green they actually trailed 34-27 at H but were able to have the 202-89 yd edge in the 2H to pull out the win 34-27. LY PSU had their B10 opener on deck and beat Delaware (-40) 63-7 and UMass (-41) with OSU on deck 63-0 and Franklin is 53-27-3 off a SU win so we look for them to handle business.

OHIO ST by 42 over Marshall - Third meeting. Ohio St is 2-0 vs Marshall and last mtg was in '10 a 45-7 win for the Buckeyes. Entering '24, Marshall is on a 9-3 SU/6-6 ATS run vs non-conference opponents and have upset two P4 opponents the last two years. Last year (-6) defeated VA Tech 24-17 and '22 (+20) in South Bend upset ND 26-21. Both teams are coming off byes as Ohio St (-37) is coming off a shutout win vs Western Michigan while Marshall (+20) was only down 24-14 entering the 4Q but threw an INT and was stopped on downs falling to VA Tech 31-14. The Buckeyes in their two games this year have yet to give up a TD as they beat Akron (-48) 52-6 and Western Michigan (-37) 56-0. Both teams are looking to stay injury free as they going into conference play so we will go with the Buckeyes here to win easily.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 20 over Buffalo - NIU is on a 13-1 SU/10-4 ATS run against Buffalo. They last met in 2021 and NIU (-1) led 24-10 3Q but NIU tied it on a FG late 4Q, but NIU won it in overtime. NIU did become the first MAC school to upset a top 5 time two weeks ago when they beat Notre Dame. However having a bye week helps here so they can regain focus and not have this be a letdown spot. Also, NIU could have a shot at the playoffs if they win out, so they cannot overlook any foe. The Bulls are 2-1 but their wins are over an FCS team and lowly UMass, and they only put up 314 yds vs UMass. NIU does have an experienced team and are strong in the trenches, while Buffalo is one of the least exp'd teams in the nation and their QB is barely hitting 50%. This is one of the top teams in the MAC vs one of the bottom teams in the MAC and we like the Huskies to put their foot on the gas pedal and get the win here by almost 3 td's.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 31 over Akron - SC won the last meeting in '18 28-3 (-29). The Gamecocks delivered us a 3rd straight Underdog POW winner last week, just missing the outright upset against LSU. SC led 17-0 2Q but lost QB LaNorris Sellers in the 2H which drastically changed the offense and they had a Pick-6 called back for a weak penalty. Akron actually trailed Colgate 17-0 last week but came back to win 31-20 (-13). The big question is Sellers health. If he doesn't return the Gamecocks will go with Robbie Ashford who is more of a runner. This is already Akron's 3rd game vs a Power-4 team after losing to Ohio St 52-6 (+48) and Rutgers 49-17 (+23). SC does have a bye week on deck with the line under 4 td's we will go with South Carolina but it's unlikely that Sellers will play.

INDIANA by 35 over Charlotte - First meeting. Charlotte has played a Big 10 team the last 3 seasons being outscored 118-55 but they are 2-1 ATS. The 49ers are just 1-11 SU and 5-7 ATS vs P4 opponents with their lone win being in '21 (+6) vs Duke, kicked a GW FG with :33 left to win 31-28. Entering this week Indiana is on 6-1 SU run vs non-conference foes including 2-0 SU/ATS this year as a 20+ point favorite. Last week in their B10 opener the Hoosiers (-3) took a 21-7 lead into half and didn't look back as they won at UCLA 42-13. Charlotte (-14) held off FCS foe Gardner-Webb LW as they stopped a 2 pt conv. w/1:55 left winning 27-26. The week prior vs UNC (+22) scored a TD late in the fourth to get the backdoor cover 38-20. Indiana has put up an AVG of 515 yds on offense and only 180 yds (!!!) on D so we look for the Hoosiers to win by 5 td's here.

WEST VIRGINIA by 10 over Kansas - Teams last met in '22 with KU (+13) getting the outright upset 55-42 in OT. KU has covered 4 of the L/5 vs WVU but those 4 covers were all as a DD underdog and their one non-cover was when the line was -4 and here the line is around a FG. The L/4 meetings have all gone 'Over' the Vegas total (66 ppg). KU is off to an 1-2 start after they were upset last week at home vs UNLV in a game they led 17-13 HT (260-198 yd edge) but scored just 3 pts & had 92 yds 2H. In 2 gms vs FBS foes KU has just 327 & 352 yds. WVU has a strong offense with QB Greene and RB's White and Donaldson & their D is allowing just 123 rush ypg (3.5), but the pass D is a concern (281, 59%). WVU is 9-3 ATS as a home favorite since 2021 and since '22 KU is just 2-5 ATS as a road underdog in Big 12 play. We see WVU as the stronger team and we feel like this line is cheap and favor the Mountaineers by DD's.

NORTH CAROLINA by 13 James Madison - 4th meeting, but first since JMU moved up to the FBS level. JMU is off a bye and have wins over Charlotte and FCS Gardner-Webb, but only put up 285 yds in that last game. UNC is 3-0 despite losing starting QB Johnson for the season in the opener. Backup Harrell started 2 wks ago (16-25) but was benched last week and Criswell took over and was 14-23 passing. This offense is led by RB Hampton who ran for 210 (8.4) and the defense is allowing just 256 ypg/16 ppg. JMU is going with QB Barnett and he has hit 60% but just a 2-1 ratio and he is the team's #2 rusher (104, 5.8) but they do face a UNC run defense that has allowed 68 ypg (3.0) and their pass rush has 10 sacks in 3 games. UNC has the big edge on offense (#50 vs #107) and also the edge on defense. JMU had to rebuild their team after HC Cignetti left and while they aren't void of talent, this is still a strong UNC team and we like them here to cover.

CLEMSON by 24 over NC State - Clemson is out for revenge after last year's 24-17 loss where the Tigers had 364-202 yard and 21-9 FD edges but were -2 TO's. Clemson has won the last nine times they've hosted NCSst and haven't lost back-to-back meetings against the Pack since '02-'03. NCSst has yet to impress. They had closer than expected wins against Western Carolina (trail 21-17 start of 4Q) and last week were down 17-6 at half vs LA Tech but won 30-20 (-20). Clemson is fresh off a bye and two weeks ago put up 56 points and 525 yards just in the 1st half vs App State. QB Klubnik threw for 378 yards and 5 td's. NCSst is 0-5 ATS in true road openers and just 4-10-1 ATS as a road dog. Grayson McCall was injured last week and rFr CJ Bailey will be making his first career start against one of the ACC's best defenses which could lead to turnovers and a dominant revenge win.

Miami, FL by 17 over USF - Miami is 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS in this series going back to '05. They last met in '13 and the 'Canes have won all 3 trips to Tampa by 28, 3 and 21 points (3-0 ATS). USF is 2-1 after winning at Southern Miss 49-24 (-12) but only had a 562-487 yard edge. Two weeks ago the 'Canes hung with Bama on the road when they only trailed 14-13 4Q before surrendering four late td's for a misleading 26 point loss. The Bulls have rushed for 269 (5.6) including 206 (4.5) vs Bama. UM has dominated all 3 foes, avg'g 53 ppg and they are +421 ypg. Last week Miami was -36' against Ball St and won 62-0. QB Cameron Ward has hit 73% for an 11-1 ratio. USF was a home dog twice last year and covered both including a 14 point loss to Bama. However, Golesh does have five losses by more than 17 points which is where this line is and exactly where we have this finishing.

Iowa by 3 over MINNESOTA - Minnesota leads the series 63-52-2 but has lost 10 of last 12. Last time here in '22, Iowa (+2) led 10-0 into 2Q but allowed Minnesota to tie the game mid-3Q, then hit a GW 21-yd FG with +28 left. The Hawkeyes are out for revenge after last year's meeting. The Gophers (+3') settled for 4 FGs then with 1:41 left were forced to punt, Iowa's PR returned the punt for a TD but was called back after a controversial fair catch call. Iowa intercepted on the drive and Minnesota came up with the 12-10 road win. The under is 6-2 since 2016. This is the first road test for the Hawkeyes of the year and they have won 11 straight road opener (8-2-1 ATS) with fans. Minnesota ranks #7 in our pass D rating but Iowa is averaging 419 yds (!!!) of offense so we will go with the Hawkeyes to get the close win here!

California by 6 over FLORIDA ST - Not much good to say about FSU right now after starting 0-3. The 'Noles have yet to reach 300 yards (274 ypg) and last week they put up just 12 points and 238 yards vs Memphis in a 20-12 loss (-6'). FSU is rushing for just 52 ypg (2.2). QB DJ Utiagalele has a 1-2 ratio. Cal comes in 3-0 and are allowing just 289 ypg. They have already beat Auburn in Jordan-Hare and last week they had a 473-276 yd edge and beat San Diego St 31-10 (-17). Cal's star RB Jaydn Ott has barely played this year but Jaivian Thomas had 169 last week. QB Fernando Mendoza has a 5-1 ratio and is hitting 70%. Cal's pass D is allowing just 49% and the Bears are #9 in our pass D efficiency ratings and are #1 in the FBS with 9 int's. We can't back FSU and Cal's 15-6 away dog record since '18 tells us another outright upset is brewing here.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 3 over Ball St - Since 2016 the home team is just 2-6 SU/1-7 ATS in this series and since 2018 there have been 4 outright upsets, 3 of them by Ball St. Last season was one of those outright upsets as CMU (-5') went to Ball St and the Cardinals held CMU to 260 yds in a 24-17 win. Ball St is off a 62-0 loss at Miami, FL last week where they were held to 115 yds and their defense allowed 750 yds including 507 pass! CMU has dropped 2 straight road games to FIU and Illinois. Two wks ago CMU outgained FIU but were -6 TO's and lost by 36 pts. Last week they only trailed ILL 13-6 HT but only got a FG in the 2H and lost 30-9. CM is just 1-5 ATS since 2022 as a MAC home favorite and Ball St is 10-4 ATS since '22 as a MAC underdog. CMU is laying almost a full td here, but we lean with Ball St as they are better than their performance last week and CMU has not been overly impressive either this season.

KENTUCKY by 28 over Ohio - KY won the last meeting in '14 20-3 (-13). 'Cats have won their last 16 vs the MAC (12-3-1 ATS). Ohio has won two straight, beating South Alabama with a backup QB and Morgan St by just 15 points. RB Anthony Tyus had 203 in the opener at Cuse but just 74 and 90 the last two weeks and faces their stiffest test yet. KY's D just held UGA to 13 points and 262 yards. The week prior they held South Carolina to just 252 and they are only giving up 64 rush ypg (2.5). The 'Cats did put up 31 points in less than 3 full quarters against Southern Miss in the opener (rest of gm was called due to weather). KY is off a huge effort and has Ole Miss on deck but after two straight losses can't look ahead. KY is 16-6 ATS vs non-conf since '18 while Ohio is 2-6 ATS in non-conf road games since '21. We think the 'Cats D shuts down Ohio's run game and easily clears the line which is under 3 td's.

Utah St by 3 over TEMPLE - First meeting. Temple is 2-1 against MWC foes but haven't played one since '11, a 37-15 bowl win vs Wyoming. Utah St is 10-9 all-time vs the AAC and last played Memphis (+7) in their Bowl in '22, US went down 24-3 at H and couldn't comeback in a 38-10 loss. LW vs Coastal Carolina, Temple (+17') closed in on a 21-17 deficit but couldn't comeback while they did have the 314-287 yd edge falling 28-20. The Aggies are coming off a rough two game stretch, losing to USC (+29) 48-0 but LW vs Utah (+18') were down 7 into the 4th, couldn't comeback losing 38-21. The Owls's are 8-4 SU (6-2 ATS in the wins) at home vs non-conf foes. Both tms haven't looked impressive so far but we will go with USU to get the win by a FG.

ARMY by 3 over Rice - These two last met in the season opener in '19 were Rice (+21') held Army to 14 points but couldn't mount anything on offense and lost 14-7. This marks the first time mtg as conf foes. Rice is just 27-50 SU in conf play while the Knights are 43-17 SU but just 26-34 ATS at home. Army was just 1-3 ATS last year as a home fav. The Owls have dropped both their FBS games this year including last week at Houston where they put up 159 yds which is their lowest in a game since '21. Army is coming off a bye but in the week prior they held FAU to 235 yds and won 24-7. We expect Rice to play better as they coming off a rivalry game and QB Warner is (Temple transfer) 2-0 ATS vs Military Academy teams so we expect the Owls to keep it close.

Rutgers by 1 over VIRGINIA TECH - Former Big East rivals. Last year they met for the first time since 2002, Rutgers snapped a 12-game losing streak in the series. Virginia Tech (+7) was only down 21-16 to start the 4Q but gave up td's on back-to-back drives to lose 35-16. The Knights RB Monangai was great in the game as he rushed for 16-143-3 while VT QB Drones had 264 all-purp yds, so look out for both to have stellar games again. VA Tech is on a 1-6 run against P4 foes including getting upset in week one vs Vanderbilt as a 13' pt favorite, 34-27. Rutgers HC Schiano is 11-5-1 ATS as an AD the last 4 years and have won four straight against P4 non-conf foes. Both teams rank in the top 10 in our experience chart and top in Pass D Eff but Schiano is off a bye and has been solid as a Away Dog so we will go with the Knights to win outright on the road.

Fresno St by 10 over NEW MEXICO - Since 2012 Fresno is 7-2 SU/ATS against NMex, but one of the SU losses was last season where the Lobos outgained them 528-229 in a 25-17 win. NMex's offense has looked good under 1st year HC Mendenhall as they are averaging 414 ypg/30 ppg but the defense has struggled, as they are allowing 566 ypg/47 ppg and are giving up 278 rush ypg (7.4) and here they face a Fresno team that just put up 525 yards/48 points last week and Fresno ran for 281 (6.5) last week, but QB Keene does have just a 5-4 ratio. NMex has not allowed a sack this season on 112 pass attempts and QB Dampier is a good dual-threat player. Fresno was just 1-3 ATS last season as a double-digit favorite and this Lobos offense can put up enough points to hang around and the line is over 2 td's as of presstime.

Kansas St by 7 over BYU - These two teams have not met since the 1997 Cotton Bowl. Kansas St is off a win over Ariz where they allowed just 251 yds after the opening drive and got a PR td to help spring them to a 31-7 win. BYU is off to a 3-0 start including an upset win at SMU two weeks ago. BYU QB Retzlaff is hitting 61% (7-3 ratio) but he is also the team's leading rusher as RB's Martin and Ropati have missed time with inj. KSt went with QB Johnson and he has a 6-1 ratio (64%) and also has 187 rush (6.7) while their top offensive weapon is RB Giddens (324, 6.6). Both defenses are playing well here as BYU is allowing just 236 ypg and KSt is giving up just 316 ypg. The Wildcats are just 1-5 ATS as an away favorite since 2022 and BYU was 3-1 ATS as a home dog a season ago. This is BYU's first true test and KSt has had two tough tests in a row, so we like the Wildcats to go to Provo and get the win by a td.

COLORADO ST by 14 over UTEP - These teams have met 35 prior times, with the last one coming in 2013. CSU is off a 28-9 loss to Colo, where they were -79 yds and -3 TO's. UTEP has yet to get in the win column, but did play Liberty close last week, trailing just 14-10 3Q, but lost 28-10. The angles do not favor CSU here as the Rams are just 1-8 ATS as a favorite under HC Norvell and are just 2-9 ATS in non-conf play since '22. CSU QB Fowler-Nicolosi has just a 1-3 ratio and star WR Horton has been banged up and only has 9 rec for 98 yds. However UTEP has struggled this season (0-3 SU) and through 3 gms are -114 ypg/-18 ppg and -8 FD's per game, plus they have the #126 pass D. CSU has slight edges on offense and defense, but have a big edge in ST's (#32 vs #123). We feel like CSU gets their offense right in this game and win by 2 td's.

Baylor by 7 over COLORADO - Baylor and Colorado have not met since CU was in Big 12 back in 2010. Baylor is off a 31-3 win over AF where they put up 478 yds incl 230 rush yds (6.1). QB Finn missed last week (rib inj) and backup Robertson was 18-24 for 248. Baylor also has 3 RB's who have topped 100 yds on the ssn. CU QB Sanders is having a strong start to the ssn, throwing for 999 yds (70%, 9-2) and he has a talented trio of WR's to throw to, but Baylor does have the #27 pass D as they are allowing just 76 pass ypg. Baylor does have a strong DLine and CU does not run the ball well. Baylor has the edge on offense, defense, ST's and coaching and Baylor is 8-6 ATS as an away dog under HC Aranda and they pulled 2 outright road upsets last season in B12 play. We think the Bears defense can slow down QB Sanders and their offense enough, plus Baylor's will be able to move the ball on Colorado and get the win in Boulder.

IOWA ST by 17 over Arkansas St - First meeting. ISU is off a bye and two weeks ago trailed Iowa 13-0 HT and 19-7 3Q, but got a long td pass and then a 54-yd FG with 6 sec left to win. Ark St opened 2-0 with 2 close wins that both easily could have been losses & lost last week at Mich. ISU has struggled running the ball early (88, 3.5) and did allow 204 rush (5.4) to Iowa. Ark St has a talented dual-threat QB in Raynor and WR Rucker is one of the top in the SBC. ISU is just 2-6 ATS under HC Campbell as a favorite of at least 3 td's and Ark St did hold their own against Mich, losing 28-18 (scored late 4Q td) and ISU does have their Big 12 opener on deck. We'll take ISU to win, but Ark St is on a 6-1 ATS run as an away underdog and we'll take them to cover.

JACKSONVILLE ST by 3 over Southern Miss - Have met twice before but not since 1946! Jax St is off to an 0-3 SU/ATS start. Last week JSU had their best game of the season on offense 423 yds incl 311 pass from QB Huff, but fell 37-34 in 2OT. SMiss trailed USF 28-21 HT but allowed 21 straight pts 2H and lost 49-24 as they allowed 562 yds incl 369 rush yds (7.2). SMiss QB Rode-maker was benched last week but looks to still have the starting job for now. SMiss's offense could have a big day vs a defense that is allowing 536 ypg/47 ypg and JSU is allowing foes to gain 126 ypg above their ssn avg. The Gamecocks are desperate for a win and we think they get that here, but JSU is laying almost a full td and we can't trust them to cover this spread with their defense struggling to stop anyone and SMiss finally was able to get their offense going last week.

Arkansas by 3 over AUBURN - Aub is 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS in this series. We cashed our 4.5★ Sept Totals GOM last week in Ark's 37-27 (-22') win over UAB. The Hogs are averaging 587 ypg including 259 rush ypg (6.6). Taylen Green only threw for 161 last week but did throw for 416 two weeks prior at OKSt. This is Aub's fourth straight home game. They lost to Cal two weeks ago and were -5 TO's but also outgained 332-286. Last week they put up 503 yards but allowed 448 and only led New Mexico 17-13 at half before pulling away to win 45-19 (-26'). Aub started rFr QB Hank Brown last week and he threw for 235 and has a 6-0 ratio. Pittman is 9-3 as an away dog. The Hogs should have won at OKSt two weeks ago and had close losses at Bama, Ole Miss and LSU last year and Aub has lost 11 home games the last 3 years. The Over has hit in 9 of the last 10 meetings (avg 64 ppg) and after Ark helped cash our Totals GOM last week this could be in the mix for a LP Totals play.

OLE MISS by 28 over Georgia Southern - Ole Miss won the only prior meeting in '16, but were -28 and only pulled it out 37-27. Rebels are laying over 5 td's this time. Last week Ole Miss finished with a 650-311 yard edge and beat Wake Forest 40-6 (-21). We cashed Power Sweep 3★'s in each of GSU's first two games. Last week the Eagles were -27' against South Carolina St. They won 42-14 but were only +33 yards and scored a garbage time td to get ahead of the spread. GSU is 6-4-1 ATS vs ranked foes. Ole Miss has their SEC opener on deck against Kentucky. GSU has topped 40 points twice and we think they can score enough to stay within the inflated line.

Tcu by 7 over SMU - Battle for the Iron Skillet. Since '13 TCU is 8-2 SU/6-3-1 ATS vs SMU. TCU has been the favorite in every meeting since 1998! SMU played over 2 weeks ago and lost at home to BYU and they made 5 fg's and lost 18-15 (-75 yds). TCU led 28-7 and 31-13 in the 3Q last week vs UCF but gave up the GW TD pass with 36 sec left and lost 35-34. TCU does have a strong pass offense led by QB Hoover (1022 yds, 70%, 8-0) and while SMU is allowing just 49% completions on the season, this is the best pass offense they have faced all season. SMU's QB's have underperformed this season as they are both hitting under 60% and TCU has the #34 pass D. The line is under a fg as of presstime, and that's where it was the last time these teams played here. SMU won that game 42-34 and we have them winning here by one score.

Tennessee by 3 over OKLAHOMA - Josh Heupel returns to Norman where he won a Nat's Title as their starting QB and was later OC under Bob Stoops from '11-'14. Tennessee put up 65 points in the first half with a 541-23 yard edge against Kent St. While most people are raving about QB Nico lamaleava, it's actually their OLine that has been most impressive. The Vols average 336 rush ypg (7.0) and have allowed just 3 sacks. Tennessee also has yet to allow an offensive td. Oklahoma is averaging just 325 ypg but the Sooners only allow 265 and just 78 rush ypg (2.2) with 11 sacks (12.8%). The Sooners have been banged up at WR and OL but could get back up to 7 injuries players this week including WR Nic Anderson who had 10 td's last year. Josh Heupel's offense hasn't traveled well. In '22 they avg'd 20 ppg less on the road than at home and last year they avg'd 9 ppg less on the road. Heupel is 5-7 SU/ATS in SEC road games. Tenn's hype train is built off beating 3 weaker foes and Oklahoma will have a fired up crowd for a night game so we like the dog here.

Over 42 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 59% winners over 42 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years. **We've gotten off to a great start, going 3-0 with 2 outright upsets to start the season!** Here is This week's Underdog Play:

LOUISIANA (+3') over Tulane

LOUISIANA over Tulane - These tms last met in the 2018 Cure Bowl where LA lost 41-24. LA has faced one of the easiest schedules in the country and have wins over Grambling and Kennesaw St. QB Woodrridge is back and is hitting 77% (4-1 ratio) while their top 2 RB's are avg'g 9.9 and 6.8 yards per carry. LA also has only allowed 241 yds and 204 yds in their F/2 gms. Tulane led KSt in the 4Q two wks ago and last week trailed at Okla by just 5 in the 4Q. QB Mensah is hitting just 59% and the OL has allowed 8 sks the L/2 gms and the Cajuns have a strong & exp'd DL line. Tulane also has given up 215 (6.5) and 182 (4.0) rushing the L/2 gms and here face a strong rush offense. Since 2017 Louisiana is 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS as a home underdog. Tulane is off two strong efforts vs Power 4 teams, and this is a letdown spot for them against a good Cajuns team who is getting points at home and they are fresh off a bye week.

TEXAS by 48 over ULM - Arch Manning is making his first career start. Texas beat ULM in '22 52-10 (-37') in the opener. Longhorns are 3-0 ATS and are +271 ypg. Both teams are fresh off a bye. ULM was +11 and beat UAB 32-6 two weeks ago but only had 296 yards in that game. QB General Booty is an Oklahoma transfer and is hitting 63% with a 1-0 ratio. Texas has their SEC opener on deck against Miss St but with Quinn Ewers already hurt they will likely pull Manning early in the 2nd half once the game is out of hand. Texas is 6-1 ATS as HF of 40+ points since '02 but they haven't been in this role under Sark. We still think Texas wins big and give the Longhorns a small lean.

WASHINGTON by 4 over Northwestern - Fourth meeting. Northwestern has dropped all 3 meetings with Washington (0-3 ATS) but all 3 games were playing the 80s. This matchup marks the first Big 10 game for the Huskies. The Huskies coming over from the Pac-12 have won 8 straight conf openers (6-2) while the Wildcats have not won a road conf opener s/'20. Northwestern is coming off a 31-7 win over an FCS school and had a shot vs Duke in week 2 but fell in OT. Washington (-6) was down 24-19 in the 3Q to Wazzou last week but went Punt/Punt/Downs in their final possessions and lost. Entering this week Washington is on a 16 game winning streak at home but NW HC Braun has his home playing physical football so we expect the Cats' to keep it close.

OKLAHOMA ST by 1 over Utah - Only prior meeting was way back in 1945! Both teams enter 3-0. Okla St is off a 45-10 win at Tulsa where QB Bowman threw for 396 yds & 5 td. However RB Gordon has gotten off to a slow start with just 194 (3.2) through 3 gms. Okla St did trail 2 wks ago at home to Ark 21-7 HT but were +2 TO's and came back to win in 2OT despite being -263 yds. Utah beat Baylor 2 wks ago at home and last wk w/o QB Rising only led Utah St 17-14 HT before pulling away 2H and winning by 21. Utah has 10 sks in 3 gms but face an exp'd OL that has yet to allow a sack. With QB Rising likely playing for Utah, the Utes are now the favorite, and since 2015 Okla St is 9-2 SU/ATS as a home underdog in Big 12 play including pulling 3 outright home B12 upsets just last season. The Pokes find a way to win this early-season B12 showdown.

NORTH TEXAS by 14 over Wyoming - First meeting. WY has struggled in their first season without former HC Bohl as the Cowboys are averaging just 202 ypg and 11 ppg on offense and QB Svoboda is hitting just 42% with a 1-3 ratio. WY has also been w/o top RB Waylee and they only have 1 rusher over 100 yds. NTex was hanging in early with Tex Tech last week but quickly found themselves down 52-7 by HT (-252 yds) and lost 66-21. However, the NTex offense has topped 500+ yds twice this season and here face a WY defense that has allowed 450+ yds to both FBS teams they have played. WY has the #105 pass D and NTex QB Morris has topped 300+ yds 2 times this ssn. The NTex D has struggled (584 ypg all'd vs FBS foes) but WY has shown little success passing. NTex is 6-0 ATS as a single-digit favorite since '21 (line is NT -9 as of presstime) and given WY's struggles we like the Mean Green by 2 td's.

TEXAS TECH by 3 over Arizona St - 5th meeting. TT got back in the win column last week as they put up 52 1H points on NTex and won easily 66-21 where QB Morton threw for 273 yds & 4 td, plus RB Brooks was back from inj and topped 100 yds (109, 6.4). ASU does have the #78 pass D and face a Tex Tech pass offense that has topped 300 yards in all 3 games. ASU faced poor offenses the first 2 games (Wyo, Miss St) and last week at TXSt, the Sun Devils allowed 400+ yds and this is the best offense they will face this ssn. ASU QB Leavitt is hitting just 59% and is ASU's #2 rusher. Tex Tech is 12-3 SU in home games under HC McGuire and the line is around a fg so they basically just have to win the game & we think they do that here, but ASU is 7-3 ATS since '22 as an away dog, so with angles in favor of both teams we will call for it at the line.

MISSOURI by 24 over Vanderbilt - Mizzou is heavily favored to reach 4-0 when hosting Vandy. We won a Power Sweep 2★ going against Mizzou last week when the Tigers were -14'. Mizzou trailed 14-6 2Q and only won 27-21. Vandy upset VTech in the opener but were a massive disappointment last week, losing to Georgia St on the road 9' point favorites. Missouri hasn't laid over 3 td's in SEC play since '18 when they beat Arkansas 38-0 (-23'). Vandy is 0-33 SU but 19-14 ATS as a road underdog of 3 td's or more in SEC play. Missouri has a bye on deck so will put full effort in and all four of Vandy's road SEC losses last year were by 24 points or more (avg loss by 29 ppg).

Usc by 7 over MICHIGAN - First Big 10 meeting. USC is 6-4 vs Michigan with 8 of their 10 meetings coming in the Rose Bowl. This marks Michigan's 4th straight home game, entering '24 they had a 22 home game winning streak. Two weeks ago vs Texas (+6') they were down 24-3 and outgained 279-88 at half and couldn't get anything going falling 31-21 to snap their home streak. Last week (-22') the Wolverines' offense came back as they put up 435 yds and won 28-18. USC is coming off a bye were HC Riley is 3-1 SU here. The Trojans offense has been averaging 500 YPG but their defense only let up 190 yds vs Utah St, which is their lowest in a single game since 2009. Michigan is going with QB Orji this week who is a dual-threat option but USC's new look. Defense under New DC D'Anton Lynn has looked good so we will go with the Trojans here!

LSU by 31 over UCLA - LSU lost the only prior meeting in '21 on the road. Now the Tigers host a UCLA team that has a brand new inexperienced head coach who can identify where his team is located (in LA) but that hasn't helped the Bruins on the field. UCLA was nearly upset by Hawaii in their opener and last week we cashed a 3★ going against UCLA in their 42-13 (+3') home loss to Indiana. LSU is rejuvenated after opening the season with a loss to the other team from LA (USC). Tigers were down 17-0 last week but rallied to win 36-33. Tigers D allowed 243 rush (5.9) but UCLA is only avg'g 84 ypg (3.6). QB Garrett Nussmeier has a 10-2 ratio while UCLA's Ethan Garbers only has a 1-3 ratio. LSU is 5-1 ATS as a home favorite vs non-conf foes. Hard to imagine taking UCLA after a 28 point beatdown at home to a lesser talented team and LSU only has South Alabama on deck so no need to hold back.

Florida by 7 over MISSISSIPPI ST - These two meet in '18 and the home team has lost the last 3 meetings SU/ATS. MSU is 4-0 SU/ATS vs Florida. This is Florida's road opener and the Gators are just 3-16 SU/6-13 ATS away from home the last four years. MSU is 1-9-1 ATS as a home dog since '19. Graham Mertz returned last week vs Texas A&M and did throw for 195 yards while rFr DJ Lagway was

Jeff Leiby is already under heat after Miss St lost at home to Toledo 41-17 which easily cashed a 2★ winner on these pages (Power Sweep ★ rated plays 10-2 last two weeks!) The Bulldogs were down 28-3 at half and allowed 454 yards for the game. QB Blake Shapen does have a 7-1 ratio and is hitting 71%. Lots of reasons to go against both teams but we do think Florida has the talent edge and their losses are to Miami, FL and A&M while MSU has lost to ASU and Toledo. We will go Gators by a td.

NOTRE DAME by 31 over Miami, Oh - Since 2017 Miami is just 1-4 ATS as an underdog of at least 20 pts incl a 52-17 loss here at NDame in 2017 where Miami was +20'. The 'Over' is also 9-1 in Miami's last 10 games as a 20+ point underdog (avg 63 ppg). NDame faced a MAC foe two weeks ago and were upset by NIU 16-14 (NDame -28) and last week they avenged that loss with a 66-7 thrashing of Purdue (led 42-0, 390-62 yd edge HT) where they put up 578 yds. Miami is off to an 0-2 start and they are off a 27-16 loss to rival Cincy at home and the Redhawks allowed 215 rush yds (6.3) and Miami has allowed 7 sks in two games. The Irish are allowing just 265 ypg and 12 ppg and their pass D ranks #2 and face Miami QB Gabbert who has just a 2-3 ratio. NDame did lose a couple of OL for the season, but that unit is still solid. After their loss 2 wks ago NDame won't take Miami lightly and we like them to cover the spread here.

TEXAS A&M by 17 over Bowling Green - First meeting. BG has been tough against the big boys under Scot Loeffler. Falcons are 5-1-1 ATS vs Power-4 teams since '21 including upset wins over Minnesota in '21 and G Tech in '23. Earlier this year BG was +34' but led Penn St 24-20 3Q and only lost by a touchdown. QB Marcel Reed started last week for A&M in their 33-20 (-3') win at Florida. Reed threw for 178 and 2 td's and rushed for 83 yards. BG is fresh off a bye. RB Terion Stewart returned after missing the Penn St game with an injury. TE Harold Fannin is one of the top TE's in the country and had 11 catches for 137 yards vs Penn St and. Stewart led the Falcons in rushing last year and had 161 in the opener. BG is 9-2-1 ATS vs the SEC since 1995. A&M has their rivalry vs Ark on deck and we've seen BG keep this games close so we lean with the dog.

Memphis by 8 over NAVY - Have met every year since '15. Memphis has won 5 straight (3-2 ATS). Last time meeting in Annapolis '22. Memphis (-5) was up 13-7 at half and then outgained Navy 276-152 in the 2H falling 37-13. LY Navy (+13') put up a season high 432 yds (6.0 YPC) and 2 chances to take the lead late in the 4th but fumble and turned it over on downs losing 28-24. Memphis HC 7-12 ATS on the road but LW at Florida St (+6') they had the 19-11 FD edge and outgained FSU 337-238 in a 20-12 win. The Middies are AVG 423 YPG and have already faced a AAC foe, Temple (-13) winning 38-11. Navy is coming off a bye while Memphis is coming off a road win and has to travel to face the triple option so we expect Navy to keep it within the line.

Fau by 3 over UCONN - First mtg as FBS foes. FAU HC Tom Herman is 21-6 ATS as underdog including in their opener at Michigan St. UConn is just 3-11 ATS as a favorite within single digits and 3-13 as a home favorite the last 10 years. FAU is coming off their first win of the year. The Owls' (-4) beat FIU 38-20 thanks to 259 yds on the ground and +5 (!!!) TOs. UConn (+16') led 21-17 into the 4Q but went Punt/INT/Punt/Missed FG in there last poss. and allowed a TD w/11:49 to go to fall to the Blue Devils 26-21. We will go with FAU and Herman to pull off the road upset win.

LA TECH by 6 over Tulsa - First meeting since '13 when Tulsa won on the road 24-14 (-3). LT played their best game under Sonny Cumbie last week when they led 17-6 vs NCSt at half. LT was only outgained 361-324 and lost 30-20 but were +20'. Tulsa has lost their last two games. They were +17' and trailed 28-0 at half last week at OKSt. They allowed 560 yards including 431 and lost 45-10. LT is 8-2 SU/7-3 ATS in home non-conf games since '18. LT QB Jack Turner returned from injury last week and threw for 281. Tulsa is 16-3-2 ATS as a road dog but we were impressed with LT last week and will call for the Bulldogs to win by just under a td.

Duke by 21 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - MT has gotten off to a rough start under new HC Derek Mason. They barely escaped against FCS Tenn Tech, were crushed at Ole Miss and last week they were +7 and lost 49-21 at home against WKU. Duke was off an upset road win over Northwestern last week but were less than impressive in a 26-21 win over UConn. The Blue Devils only had a 409-314 yard edge. QB Maalik Murphy does have an 8-3 ratio and MT is dead last in our pass D rankings, allowing 77% with a 10-1 ratio and 384 ypg! MT is 1-10 SU/4-7 ATS vs Power-4 foes. Duke is 31-2 SU/25-8 ATS vs non-Power-5 foes but haven't covered in either game this year against Elon or UConn and Manny Diaz is just 9-16 ATS when favored. We do think Duke is the better team and a win here makes them 4-0 going into ACC play so we call for a fired up Duke team to win by 3 td's.

SAM HOUSTON by 17 over New Mexico St - NMST won their first meeting last year 27-13 with a 458-367 yard edge. SH has been impressive this year. They upset Rice in the opener on the road and last week had a 422-308 yard edge in a 31-13 win over Hawaii. NMST's only impressive game was a close loss to Liberty. They also barely avoided an upset loss to FCS SEMO and last week were demolished at Fresno St 48-0. The Aggies were outgained 525-138. QB's Parker Awad and Deuce Hogan have combined to complete just 36.5% for 93 pass ypg and a 2-4 ratio. The Aggies also have allowed 11 sacks (14.9%). Their D is allowing 450 ypg and allowed 217 rush to Liberty and 281 at Fresno last week.

Toledo by 3 over WKU - First meeting. WKU is 7-0 SU vs MAC foes since '14 but haven't played once since '19 in their bowl. Toledo cashed us a 2★ winner on these pages last week when they were +10' at Miss St and won easily 41-17. QB Tucker Gleason has a 9-0 ratio and faces a WKU pass D that is allowing 68% and 266 pass ypg and are #133 in our pass D rankings. WKU just put up 49 points and 631 yards at Middle Tenn and won 49-21 (-7). The 'Toppers were without QB TJ Finley but backup Caden Veltkamp hit 27-30 for 398 yards and 5 td's. WKU is 20-11 SU at home under Helton while Toledo is 24-20 SU on the road. We like both teams so it's hard to pick a winner. Toledo's win last week was a little more impressive so we give the Rockets a 3 point edge.
