## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Indiana over NORTHWESTERN** - Last met in '19, Indiana held NW to 199 yds and 12 FD's in a 34-3 win. Indiana 5-0 for the first time since 1967 and 5-0 ATS were tied 21-21 late in the 3Q but then scored TD's in the next 3 of 4 possessions winning 42-28 (-7) even though they were -4 in TOs cashing our 4★ top newsletter play and 3★ LPS winners! NW is coming off a bye but in the previous week played Washington in their B10 Opener. The Wildcats (+11') were held to a program low 112 yds and lost 24-5. Prior to this year, the last time IU was a conference road favorite was in '20 at Mich St and won 24-0 (-7). Indiana this year has an AVG +273 yard edge, outscoring their foes 274-65. Indiana QB Rourke is hitting for 73% with an 11-2 ratio and they have 4 rushers that are over 100 yds. NW has yet to find an answer at QB they are just completing 54% of their passes. Cignetti is now 45-22 ATS going back to his FCS days and the Hoosiers have been a money machine, so we will keep riding them for our top newsletter play this week!

**FORECAST: INDIANA by 28**

**3★ CALIFORNIA (+) over Miami, FI** - Miami is leaving the state of Florida for the first time this year and travels 2,400 miles to Berkley, CA. Cal is 3-1 this season and fresh off a bye. The Bears had a 410-284 yd edge two weeks ago but settled for five fg's (missed 3) and lost 14-9. RB Jaydn Ott returned from injury prior to the bye and should be 100% this week. The Bears D is allowing just 288 ypg and their pass D is #5, allowing just 51% and they lead the country with 10 int's. Miami dominated their first four foes but last week they trailed 34-24 at home to VTech before scoring 2 td's and won after VT's Hail Mary was ruled not incomplete. Cam Ward has an 18-4 ratio and Miami has topped 500 yards in all five games but face their toughest test yet. While we won't call for the outright upset, we do like Cal to cover as double digit underdogs. HC Wilcox is 30-16 as an underdog including 12-5 as a home dog.

**FORECAST: Miami, FI by 3**

**3★ OREGON ST over Colorado St** - Only 4th meeting all-time. Last met in 2017 at CSU where the Rams won 58-27. CSU is off a bye week and sit at 2-2 on the season, but their wins are over FCS Northern Colo and UTEP. Oregon St is also off a bye and 2 weeks ago they delivered a 3★ newsletter play and a 4★ late phone winner for us when they beat Purdue at home 38-21! Oregon St is rushing for 268 ypg (5.4) led by RB's Griffin (413, 6.2) and Hankerson (372, 5.0) and their OL has all'd just 6 sacks in 4 games. CSU runs the Air Raid offense but are only throwing for 149 ypg (59%) and QB Fowler-Nicolosi is only hitting 60% with a 2-4 ratio and WR Horton has under 100 yds receiving. Oregon St also has the #17 pass defense and have the overall defensive edge here (#60 vs #102). Since 2021 ORegon St is 13-1 SU/12-2 ATS at home as a favorite and even laying around 2 td's here, we're confident that the Beavers win here by 3+ td's as Reaser stadium at night is a tough task for any visiting foe & will go back to them as a key selection!

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Clemson over FLORIDA ST** - Clemson is out for legit revenge for last year's OT loss where the Tigers had a 429-311 yd edge but lost thanks to a fumble returned for a td in the 4Q and a missed fg that would have put the Tigers up 10 late. FSU is now 1-4 and their hopes of reaching a bowl are dim with games against Miami and Notre Dame still ahead. DJ Ujagalelei has a 4-6 ratio but is out for this game with a finger injury. Backup Brock Glenn hit just 37% with a 0-2 ratio last year. Since Clemson's loss to Georgia they've covered all 3 games and avg 547 ypg and 55 ppg. Cade Klubnik has a 12-2 ratio and frosh WR Bryant Wesco has 238 yards on just 7 catches. FSU's hasn't hit 300 yards yet this season and their D just allowed 458 yards at SMU last week. The 'Noles only trailed 14-9 at half then were outgained 236-100 in the 2nd half. FSU's Oline has been their biggest issue, allowing 12 sacks and they average just 65 rush ypg (2.4). Clemson had won 7 straight vs FSU before last year's loss including 3 where they were favored by over 2 td's. We expect the Tigers to get their revenge by over 3 td's.

**FORECAST: Clemson by 24**

**2★ GEORGIA TECH over Duke** - GT has won the last 3 meetings vs Duke. LTH was Brent Key's first home game as HC and the Jackets won 23-20 (+3) in OT. Duke is 5-0 for the first time since 1994. The Blue Devils trailed 20-0 3Q at home last week against North Carolina but won 21-20. GT is fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they had a 410-326 yd edge but had a blocked fg returned for a td and fumbled in the EZ. The Jackets Oline has allowed 0 sacks all season. QB Haynes King has a 6-1 ratio, is hitting 74% and is their #2 rusher with 206 (5.2). We have the defenses basically even in this game but GT has a huge edge on offense (#17 vs #104). Duke only had a +45 yd edge vs Middle Tenn two weeks ago. This is Duke's sixth straight week playing and they are off an emotional win while GT is fresh and off a misleading loss. GT is laying just over a td and we have the Jackets by over 2 td's so they get the call for a 2★ newsletter play!

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY OCTOBER 3RD

**Texas St by 17 over TROY** - Since becoming SBC foes Troy is 9-0 SU/7-2 ATS vs Texas St, winning by an avg of 21 ppg. Last season TXSt (+6') led 10-7 HT but were outscored 24-3 2H and lost 31-13. TXSt is off B2B close losses and last week led Sam Houston 22-0 2Q and 39-21 3Q but allowed the game's final 19 pts and lost 40-39. Troy has yet to beat an FBS team this season as they lost to ULM 13-9 with QB Crowder going down 1Q (ankle) and bkp Kilcrease was just 6-10. This is the first time TXSt will be the favorite against Troy, and do have to travel on short rest. However, Troy is only avg'g 292 ypg vs FBS foes and do have the #122 pass D (allowing 70%) and face TXSt QB McCloud who is hitting 69% with a 12-3 ratio. Give us the Bobcats to get the win in their SBC opener by over 2 td's.  
**Sam Houston by 14 over UTEP** - UTEP is 3-0 all-time vs SH. Last year SH was -3' and led 27-13 3Q then allowed 3 straight td drives. Tied 34-34 UTEP went 41/3 & kicked the GW fg. SH is 4-1 after their upset win over Texas St last week. SH trailed 39-21 3Q then scored the last 19 points to win 40-39 (+10). QB Hunter Watson only threw for 95 yards and has a 5-5 ratio but did rush for 105 and 2 td's. UTEP is still looking for it's first win under Scotty Walden. They are fresh off a bye but have lost all 3 vs FBS foes by at least 10 points along with a loss to FCS Southern Utah. The situation favors UTEP who is at home with extra rest while Sam Houston is playing on short rest. We are still taking the Bearcats to win by two td's as they've been far more impressive.

### FRIDAY OCTOBER 4TH

**Jacksonville St by 21 over KENNESAW ST** - Two recent additions to the FBS level meet for the 5th time. KSU won the first 3 meetings including a playoff game in '17 but Jax St won the most recent meeting in '22 35-28 in OT. Jax St lost their first 3 games then crushed Southern Miss 44-7 with a 509-246 yard edge prior to their bye week. KSU is 0-4 and just lost to FCS UT Martin 27-13 (+1'). The Owls are -177 ypg and they average just 216 ypg. Jax St averages are -69 ypg and average 395 ypg. Jax St QB Tyler Huff led Furman to a 31-28 win over KSU last year. KSU has the situation edge, coming off a bye while Jax St has short rest. Jax St has talent and coaching edges here so we will still take the Gamecocks by 3 td's.

**TCU by 21 over Houston** - TCU comes into this game off a win in their B12 opener, where they were +161 yds in a 38-27 game at Kansas, while UH is off to an 0-2 start in league play and have yet to score a point in B12 gms after getting beat 34-0 at Cincy and 20-0 against Iowa St. UH has only put up 237 ypg in conf play and have just 164 total pass yds in the L/2 gms. UH is also -6 TO's in the L/2 gms. TCU QB Hoover is hitting 70% on the season (14-4 ratio) and has 1,774 yds and 4

WR's are over 200 yds. UH is holding teams to 294 ypg and are holding foes to 124 ypg under their season avg (#13! FBS!). TCU is only allowing 330 ypg and are only giving up 52% completions. UH QB D.Smith only has a 2-5 ratio on the season. TCU has the big offensive edge (#11 vs #109). TCU is 5-2 ATS has a HF in B12 play under HC Dykes and we like the Horned Frogs here by 3 td's.  
**OREGON by 28 over Michigan St** - 8th meeting. The home team in this series is 6-0 SU and 4-2 ATS. Last meeting was in the 2018 Redbox Bowl, Oregon (-1') scored a TD with 11:19 left to win 7-6. LW Oregon (-25) led 28-10 with a 302-54 yds edge but only had four 2H possessions to score one TD to beat UCLA 34-13. MSU (+23') had multiple chances in the 1H to keep the game close but fumbled twice in the redzone and were down 24-7 at half, in the 2H the Spartans couldn't get anything going only having 4 FD falling 38-7 to Ohio St. Michigan St HC Smith is familiar with Oregon as he was the HC at Oregon St (2-4 SU/3-3 ATS). The Ducks QB Gabriel is hitting at 81.5% with a 9-1 ratio while MSU QB Chiles has a 5-9. Oregon does a showdown with Ohio St on deck and is 8-3 ATS a 20+ point favorite last three years so we will keep it right near the line.

**UNLV by 14 over Syracuse** - UNLV is off to a 4-0 start after they picked up a 59-14 win against Fresno St where we picked up a 3★ winner on these pages and a 4★ late phone winner on the Rebels!! UNLV had to go with new QB Hajj-Malik Williams after their starter left, but Williams was 13-16 passing (182, 3-0 ratio) and ran for 119 (9.9). Cuse is off a win vs FCS Holy Cross where they only put up 319 yds. This is the first road game for 'Cuse and there will be a good crowd on hand with UNLV ranked for the first time in program history. UNLV is only allowing 313 ypg/14 ppg and are only giving up 87 rush ypg (3.0) and they have the #28 pass D as they are allowing only a 4-9 ratio on 57%. Cuse's OL has allowed 4 sacks each of the L/2 games and UNLV's pass rush has 12 sks (8.5%) on the season. UNLV is 14-4 ATS under HC Odom and are playing with a ton of confidence and we think they keep rolling with a 2-td win here.

### SATURDAY OCTOBER 5TH

**Pittsburgh by 6 over NORTH CAROLINA** - NC is 8-2 SU/7-3 ATS in ACC meetings vs Pitt. The Tar Heels won the last two by 18 & 17 and the Over has hit in 8 of the last 10. Pitt is fresh off a bye and 4-0 including two 4Q come-from-behind wins over Cincy and WVU. Bama transfer Eli Holstein has excelled in Kade Bell's offense with a 12-2 ratio (67%) and Western Carolina transfer Desmond Reid is a weapon in the backfield (319, 7.3). NC opened 3-0 but they've lost their last two, giving up 70 points and 611 yards to James Madison then last week they blew a 20-0 lead at Duke and lost 21-20. The Tar Heels have actually had the yardage edge in all five games. Pat Narduzzi is 31-18 ATS on the road. Pitt is favored by under a fg. They've beaten two teams that we feel are better than North Carolina and a win probably puts Pitt in the rankings so we will go with the Panthers by six.

**FLORIDA by 3 over Ucf** - FL is 2-1 SU but UCF won the last meeting in '21 29-17. UCF was 3-0 and -13' last week vs Colorado but lost 48-21 despite a 461-418 yd edge. The Knights avg 543 ypg including 326 rush (6.2) and have put up the most yards all four of their opponents have allowed. QB KJ Jefferson won in The Swamp last year at Arkansas but HC Malzahn lost his only trip to Florida during his time at Auburn. Gators are fresh off a bye and won the week prior at Miss St 45-28 (-6'). The Gators' two losses are to teams that are combined 9-1 this year. Gators rush D is a concern after allowing 310 vs A&M and 240 vs Miss St. Florida does have a solid ST's edge which could be the difference and Billy Napier needs this game to save his job for the time being. This is basically a pickem so we will go with the home team by a fg.

**East Carolina by 14 over CHARLOTTE** - Second meeting for these in-state foes. In last years meeting Charlotte (+6') had a 323-127 yard edge but the Pirates had a chance to tie the game with 2:29 left and missed a 48 yard FG, CLT won 10-7. East Carolina is 4-7 SU and 5-6 ATS vs FBS teams from North Carolina since 2013. LW Charlotte (+5) scored a TD with :47 left to get the 21-20 lead but Rice went down the field and missed a 40 yd FG as time expired to win. East Carolina (-3) was down at half 13-10 but scored two td's in the 3Q and held onto a 30-20 win. Charlotte as a Home Dog is just 3-10 ATS last four seasons while ECU haven't been a road favorite since '22. Charlotte QB Brown is ? for this game (check status). The 49ers have been outgained in each game and the Pirates are holding their foes to 15 yds below their season avg so we will go with East Carolina by 2 td's on the road.

**LOUISVILLE by 3 over Smu** - SMU is traveling to UL for their first ACC road game and Mustangs won the last two meetings back in 1983-84. SMU is 4-1 and made a statement in their ACC debut by knocking off the defending champs Florida St 42-16. Mustangs only led 14-9 at half but dominated 2nd half with a 236-100 yard edge. UL was fortunate to beat GTech two weeks ago then lost at Notre Dame 31-24. Two of UL's td's came on short drives of just 9 & 24 yards. QB Tyler Shough has an 11-1 ratio but SMU is #12 in pass eff D (51%, 10-9). SMU's QB Kevin Jennings has a 6-1 ratio and is their #2 rusher. RB Brashard Smith (Miami transfer) has 506 and 7.3 ypc. SMU didn't look good at the start of their season but their last two games have been impressive. We felt the Mustangs were a darkhorse contender in the ACC prior to the seasons and they are starting to look like that team. If the Mustangs pull the upset, they will likely be favored in the rest of their ACC games so we expect a highly motivated team to keep it close.

**GEORGIA by 28 over Auburn** - Georgia has won the last six in the Deep South's Oldest Rivalry. The Bulldogs had covered five straight until last year when Aub was +14' and led 17-10 3Q. Georgia ultimately won 27-20 and finished with a 420-307 yd edge. Aub has lost their last 8 in Sanford Stadium (0-8 ATS) with an average score of 33-11 and the Tigers haven't topped 10 points in their last six trips to UGA. Aub snatched defeat from the jaws of victory last week when QB Payton Thorne threw a pick-6 as the Tigers were trying to run out the clock vs Oklahoma. Aub finished with a 482-291 yard edge and were +15 FD's. The week prior they had a +97 yd edge but were -3 TO's and lost to Arkansas. Now they are on the road against an angry Georgia team off their loss to Bama. UGA's comeback after being down 30-7 at half vs Bama was impressive. Kirby Smart is only 4-10 ATS as a home favorite of 21+ vs SEC foes but 9-5 ATS off a SU loss. Aub is already -11 TO's and if they keep throwing the ball to the other team then this will get real ugly.

**Tulane by 20 over UAB** - The series is tied 6-6 (Tulane 6-5-1 ATS). Last year was their first mtg as AAC foes. Tulane (-21') went down 20-7 in the 2Q but scored 3 unanswered TD's to go up 28-20 then sealed the game with a TD with :47 left to win 35-23. UAB has covered the last three matchups including last time in Birmingham, 21-24 (+3) win in '18. Tulane is 4-1 ATS on the year including last week vs USF. The Wave (-4') went up 31-7 at H and had the 528-201 yards edge in a 45-10 win. Tulane QB Mensah has a 9-2 ratio while UAB QB Zeno is completing 69% of his passes just having a 6-5 ratio. UAB has let up 234 yards on the ground in FBS play and last week (+4') fell to Navy 41-18 due to letting up 227 rush yds and 225 pass yds (25 YPC). UAB is a perfect 9-0 SU in B2B conf home games and Tulane went 0-5 LY as a DD conf favorite but the Green Wave were dominant last week and UAB has struggled in Diller's 2nd year so we are taking Tulane by almost 3 td's.

**COASTAL CAROLINA by 3 over Old Dominion** - 3rd meeting as SBC foes. Last season CC trailed 21-6 late 3Q but scored 3 td's in the final 17 minutes, incl the GW score with :23 left 4Q for the 28-24 win. CC is off a bye and in their last game they suffered a 43-24 loss to UVA (-141 yds, -2 TO). ODU got their first win of the season last week when they went to Bowling Green and got the GW score with :24 left 4Q to pull the upset 30-27 (+10). ODU nearly upset S.Car in the opener and were close with VTech at the half. CC QB Vasko only has a 4-2 ratio and is hitting just 53% and ODU's pass defense is a solid #65 and have only all'd 3 td passes to 6 int's. Since joining the SBC ODU is 7-1 ATS as an away dog in conf play and with 14 of their last 16 gms finishing within 7 pts, we'll call for ODU to keep this game within one score.

**Western Michigan by 4 over BALL ST** - WMich has won the last 2 meetings and home team is 5-2 SU/4-3 ATS. Both teams are 1-3 and looking for their first win over an FBS foe. WMich was outgained 286-93 in the 1H at Marshall last week but were only down 17-3. The Broncos actually tied the game in the 4Q but Marshall went 70/3 td and WM reached Marshall territory but fumbled and was SOD on their final two drives. Ball St was crushed 63-7 at James Madison last week. The Cardinals allow 530 ypg and are dead last in our pass efficiency D allowing 311 pass ypg, 70% and a 15-1 ratio! WMich is only slightly better at #119 in our pass D efficiency rankings (224 pass ypg, 65%, 5-1). Ball St has the edge on ST's but WMich has the edge on offense and defense so we will take the Broncos to win but side with the underdog Cardinals. With both two defenses struggling and the Over hitting 7 of the last 8 in the series this game will be in the mix for our 4.5★ Totals play this weekend.

**Wake Forest by 3 over NC STATE** - This is the longest continuous streak in college football, having been played every year since 1910. NCSt is 6-4 SU/ATS and the home team is 14-3 SU/ATS though the 'Pack did win on the road last year 26-6 (-1). Both teams have struggled in '24. WF is 1-3 with close losses to Virginia (led by 13 4Q) and Louisiana last week when the Deacons missed a 41 yd fg on the final play that would have forced OT. NCSt has yet to have an impressive game. They trailed FCS Western Carolina to start 4Q, trailed LA Tech 17-6 at half and last week beat Northern Illinois 24-17 but had just 171 yards and were +4 TO's. The Gamecocks two losses were blown out by Tennessee and trailed Clemson 59-14 4Q then scored three garbage time td's. NCSt QB Grayson McCall is still a ? to return and CJ Bailey only has thrown for 468 yards in 3 starts (2-2 ratio). WF has a big edge on offense, putting up 118 ypg more than their opponents allow on avg. We think the Deacons are prime to pull an upset here and Clawson is 18-12 ATS as an AD since '15.

**TOLEDO by 10 over Miami, Oh** - After not meeting from 2012-2022 these MAC foes will meet for the 3rd time in two seasons. Last year in the reg ssn Toledo won 21-17 and Miami QB Gabbert broke his leg, but Miami got their revenge in the MAC title game LY where the Redhawks (+7) won 23-14 despite being -64 yds but were +2 TO's. Miami got their first win of '24 last week against UMass but it took OT to win 23-20 and yards were nearly even (349-344). Toledo is off a bye and 2 weeks ago lost at WKU 26-21 as they threw a late int while driving to potentially win the game. Toledo also faced UMass earlier this ssn and despite winning by 15 pts, Toledo was outgained 384-258. Toledo does have an impressive win over Miss St 41-17 and their QB Gleason is hitting 61% with an 11-2 ratio and the Rockets run D is allowing just 96 ypg (2.9) and they have 12 sks. Miami QB Gabbert is hitting just 57% with a 3-6 ratio and are avg'g just 306 ypg on offense. The Rockets have been more impressive this season & we like them to grab the win by DD's.

**MARSHALL by 10 over Appalachian St** - 5th straight year meeting, but 3rd meeting as SBC foes. The last 2 times Marshall hosted App St they pulled the outright upset and overall the home team in this series is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS. This is the 1st time the Herd will be the favorite over App St as FBS foes. App St has not played since Sept 19th after last week's game was cancelled due to Hurricane Helene. In their last game vs Sala at home App St fell behind 28-7 HT and lost 48-14 as they allowed 320 rush yds (7.4). Marshall is off a win vs WMich last week where they led 17-3 HT (286-93) but needed a 4Q td with 7:39 left to go up 7 and win 27-20. Marshall is rushing for 194 ypg (5.0) this season led by RB AJ Turner (378, 12.6) and QB Stone Earle has a 7-1 ratio. Marshall also has the big edge on defense (#55 vs #112) as they have one of the top DLines in all of the SBC. Marshall is 11-3 SU since 2022 in home games and with the line around a FG all they really have to do is win the game to cover and we think they do that here.

**Bowling Green by 21 over AKRON** - BG is 12-3 SU/11-4 ATS since '07 but Akron won 3 of the last 7 and covered 3 straight from '20-'22. Last year BG was -7 at home and won 41-14 but only had a 297-279 yd edge. Falcons are off an upset loss to Old Dominion which is their 3rd straight close loss and the first two were at Penn St and Texas A&M. Akron is 1-4 with their only win coming against Colgate. Last week the Zips were -262 yards at Ohio and lost 30-10 (+9). BG is +2 ypg while Akron is -184. BG's TE Harold Fannin is a Mackey Award candidate after topping 100 yards in three straight. After losing three straight BG should get a dominant win and they are favored by just over 2 td's. Loeffler's team was 2-0 as an AF last year including a 30 point win at Kent St so and could do the same here.

**VIRGINIA by 6 over Boston College** - BC has won five of the last six meetings. Last year BC (-3) allowed a 39 yd td on final play of the 1H and trailed 21-7 but QB Castellanos threw two td passes in the 3Q and BC won 27-24. UVA enters 3-1 and fresh off a bye. BC is 4-1 including a road upset over Florida St. They've been held under 300 yards in 3 straight including last week when QB Castellanos was out and they came from behind to beat WKU 21-0 (-8). UVA has topped 30 points in 3 of their 4 games and QB Anthony Colandrea is hitting 68% with a 7-4 ratio and they have two RB's with over 200 rush yards. Castellanos could return this week but Virginia has the better offense so our lean is with the Cavaliers.

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 14 over UMass** - 3rd meeting. Only 2 prior meetings came as MAC foes back in 2012 and 2013 with NIU winning both games 63-19 and 63-0. NIU has dropped their last 2 games after beating Notre Dame in week 2, but held the yds edge in both their loss to Buffalo (+175 yds) and NC State (+108) but they were done in partially by a -5 TO ratio the L/2 gms. UMass has already faced 4 MAC teams this season and are 0-4 SU/2-2 ATS as they covered at Toledo and at Miami, Oh. NIU does have the edge on offense (#95 vs #118) and an even bigger edge on defense (#44 vs #123) as they are holding foes to 101 ypg under their season avg (#99 FBS!). UMass does have QB Phommachanh who is hitting 59% and is also the team's top rusher (226, 3.1). NIU is just 5-13 ATS as a home favorite and do have a more important trip to Bowling Green on deck and will just be looking to get back on track with a win & the spread is over 2 td's.

**Navy by 10 over AIR FORCE** - Air Force is on a 6-2 SU/ATS run vs Navy since '16. Last year Air Force (-10) held Navy to just 20 yds in the 1H (7-0) and got a TD INT with 3:51 left in a 17-6 win. Navy is AVG'ing 46 PPG and 466 YPG this year. Last week the Middies (-4) scored on 7 of their 8 possessions in the game to rout UAB 41-18. AF (0-4 ATS) was up 13-7 at half but allowed Wyoming to score on each of their possessions in the 2H to fall 31-19 (-4). Navy is 4-0 for the first time s/'17 and in the next week beat AF to be 5-0 for the first time s/'04. The Middies have gone over in all four games this year but the trend is under in this series which is 15-4-1. Air Force is getting outgained by 135 YPG and -17 FD edge in FBS play so we will go with the Middies here.

**Alabama by 31 over VANDERBILT** - Vandy has lost their last 23 in this series. Bama hasn't lost in Nashville since 1969. Vandy is fresh off a bye and has covered twice as an underdog this year, upsetting VTech 34-27 (+7) in the opener and nearly upset Mizou (+18) prior to their bye week. Bama is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS and is off their big win over UGA where the Tide led 28-0 2Q. UGA rallied to lead late but 17 YO frosh Ryan Williams made a 75 yard catch and run for the GW td with 2:18 left. Don't expect Bama to take it easy on Vandy. They've won the last 3 over Vandy by a combined score of 148-3. Crimson Tide will have the crowd edge in Nashville. Diego Pavia has a 6-0 ratio against our #44, #105 & #133 pass D's but now faces Bama who has our #1 ranked pass D, allowing 53% and a 4-5 ratio. Vandy's D allowed 36 points and 426 yards vs Georgia St. Clark Lea is just 6-15 ATS at home. Bama by a lot!

**BOISE ST by 35 over Utah St** - Boise St has dominated this series of late, as they have won and covered the last 7 meetings and have won the L/5 meetings by an average of 28 points. USU is just 1-3 to start this season & their lone win is vs an FCS school. The Aggies are off a bye and in their last game they got QB Petras back and USU led 21-17 HT but then were outscored 28-8 2H and lost 45-29. Boise is off a 45-24 win vs Wash St where RB Jeanty had another big game, rushing for 259 yds (10.4) and 4 td's! For the season he is up to 845 yards (10.3) and 13 td's in 4 games! USU's run defense is allowing 197 ypg (5.1) and allowed USC to rush for 249 (6.7) and Utah ran for 221 (5.4). Boise also has a strong pass rush (19 sacks!) led by DE Hassanein and they are holding foes to 27 ypg under their average while the USU defense is allowing foes to gain 89 ypg above their season average (#130 FBS!). This looks like a complete mismatch, and even with the line creeping up to 4 td's, we will ride the series history and go with the Broncos by 5 td's!

**ARIZONA ST by 7 over Kansas** - First meeting. ASU comes into this game off a bye and two weeks ago suffered their first loss of the season, losing at Texas Tech 30-22 despite having the yds edge (+42 yds). KU has yet to beat an FBS team this season as they have dropped their last 4 games, but 3 of those losses were by 6 pts or less and they had the lead in the 2H in all 4 of those losses. Last week KU led TCU 24-21 3Q but all'd a 89-yd punt return td and a 59 yd td pass and lost 38-27. KU's best offensive threats are their RB's Neal (513, 6.0) and Hishaw (262, 6.9) and QB Daniels has had a disappointing season, hitting just 53% with a 5-8 ratio. ASU stops the run well, allowing just 82 ypg (2.6) and the pass D is only allowing 59% and they have the #38 pass defense. ASU is led by RB Skattebo (433, 5.0) and KU has allowed 160 rush ypg (4.2) ypg the L/3 games. KU is just 5-10 ATS as an away underdog under HC Leipold and we'll call for the Sun Devils at home by a td.

**SAN JOSE ST by 10 over Nevada** - Nevada has won 4 of the past 6 meetings SU, but teams have split the last 6 meetings ATS with SJSt covering twice as underdogs. SJSt is off to a surprising 3-1 start after entering '24 as one of the least exp'd teams in the country. The Spartans are off a bye and in their last game nearly upset Wash St on the road, losing 54-52 in OT (+12'). Nevada is also off a bye and have already equaled their win total from 2023. Two weeks ago they beat FCS E.Wash 49-16 and gained 534 yds. Nev is getting improved play from QB Lewis (68%, 7-4 ratio) and RB Red had 394 yards (7.1) on the season. Nev does only have the #88 pass defense and here face a SJSt pass attack led by QB Brown (1290, 62%, 13-4) and WR Nash already has 50 catches (637, 12.7, 8 td). San Jose St does have the #24 pass defense as they are allowing just 51% with a 5-8 ratio. Both teams have surprised us, but we've been more impressed with the Spartans and they are at home here and we like them to get the win by DD's.

**Virginia Tech by 3 over STANFORD** - VT is traveling roughly 2,200 miles for their fourth road game in the first six weeks. VT was ranked in the preseason but is off to a disappointing 2-3 start and their 3 losses are by a combined 14 points. In VT's two wins they only led Marshall by 3 at half (won by 17) and ODU by 4 at half (won by 20). Stanford returned nearly their entire team from last year and have been far more competitive than expected. They upset Syracuse on the road two weeks ago then only trailed 17-7 at half at Clemson last week and were only outgained 405-361 but lost 40-14 (+22). The Hokies haven't played well enough to warrant laying a td on the road and Stanford is playing much better than expected so we will lean with the underdog.

**ARIZONA by 10 over Texas Tech** - 34th meeting, but just the 2nd since 1989! Arizona is off to a 3-1 start this season and are off a road upset of Utah last week 23-10. Texas Tech is off to a 4-1 start this season and are off a 44-41 win vs Cincy last week. Arizona is led by QB Fifita, but he has had his early ups and downs. Arizona also has star WR McMillian, who has 29 catches for 503 (17.4). They face a Texas Tech pass defense that just gave up 426 yards to Cincy last week and overall have just the #90 ranked pass defense. Arizona does have a big edge on defense (#41 vs #97) as they are holding foes to 27 ypg under their season average but have given up some big plays at times and have allowed 211 rush (5.6) to NMem and 235 rush (5.7) to KSt and TT RB Brooks has 551 (5.3) through 5 games. TT is just 2-4 ATS as a road underdog in B12 play under McGuire and we think this will be a high-scoring game with the home squad winning by 2 scores.

**Tennessee by 7 over ARKANSAS** - Ark has covered 9 of the last 11 vs Tenn and won the last 3 outright though they haven't met since 2020. Tenn is fresh off a bye after beating Oklahoma 25-15 (-7). Vols led that game 19-3 before a late Sooners rally and Vols finished w/a 345-222 yard edge. Ark is 3-2 after their 21-17 loss to A&M but they covered as 6 point dogs. Sam Pittman is 19-9-1 as an underdog and Hogs are getting over 2 td's. here. Vols have covered all four games and their defense is allowing just 176 ypg but their four opponents have all struggled on offense. Arkansas averages 495 ypg and is putting up 79 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. QB Taylen Green is a different QB than Tennessee has seen and the Vols struggled with Oklahoma's dual threat QB at the end of the game. Hogs should have a live home crowd for a night game and Pittman is 7-1 ATS as a dog vs ranked teams so we think they keep it closer than expected. We used the Over in Ark/Aub to cash our Sept Totals GOM and the Over could be in the mix with these offenses combining for 1,061 ypg!

**Army by 14 over TULSA** - Second meeting. Tulsa won only prior meeting 49-39 (-15) back in '07. Army 4-0 for the third time in the last 30 years. The Knights have had a stellar start to the season holding foes to 74 yards below their season average amd on the ground are going for 371 YPG. The Black Knights are 4-0 ATS on the year and have been double digits in two of those games including last week. Army (-12') put up their most yards since '21, 489. The Knights got out to a 28-0 lead half way through the 3Q and didn't look back holding Temple to -5 rush yards winning on the road, 42-14. Tulsa (+6) was outgained by 203 yards and let up a season high 618 yards losing 52-20 at North Texas. Tulsa is 28-13-1 as a DD dog but this year (+17) got outgained 560-352 vs Oklahoma St losing 45-10. Army has looked dominate so far, we will lean with them!

## SOUTH CAROLINA (+9') over Ole Miss

**SOUTH CAROLINA over Ole Miss** - These two last met in the 2020 Covid season when Ole Miss was -13' and won 59-42. SC won the previous three matchups including two in Oxford ('08 & '18). Ole Miss was upset last week by Kentucky when they were favored by 15 points. The Rebels four wins have come against teams that are a combined 6-12 with only two wins over FBS foes. South Carolina is fresh off a bye. The Gamecocks beat that same Kentucky team 31-6 and we cashed our underdog POW when SC led #12 LSU 17-0 2Q but lost QB Sellers and lost by a fg. Ole Miss allows just 46 rush ypg (1.4) but they haven't faced a dual threat QB and SC's Rocket Sanders is the best RB they've faced and Sellers is a dual threat and returns this week. SC also has a deep & talented Dline that has 14 sacks including 5 against KY while Ole Miss just allowed 4 sacks last week. The Gamecocks are 15-9 ATS at home. Our Underdog POW is 4-1 this season with 3 outright upsets and we think the SC gets the job done here for yet another upset winner!

**IOWA ST by 17 over Baylor** - Last season's 30-18 win by Iowa St (-3) at Baylor snapped a 5 game ATS losing streak for the Cyclones against the Bears. ISU is 4-0 on the season and are led by a strong defensive unit that has allowed a total of 29 points in 4 games and are holding foes to 95 ypg under their season average (#12 FBS!). Baylor is just 2-3 on the season with losses to Utah, Colorado and BYU. Last week they fell behind 28-7 2Q but came back and cut it to one score and lost 34-28. BU has switched to QB Robertson and he threw for 324 yds last week, but here faces an ISU pass defense allowing just 103 ypg (49%) and ranked #6 as they have allowed just 1 pass td and have 7 int's. Baylor's run defense did just allow 169 (5.5) to BYU last week and here face an ISU rush attack that put up 240 (6.3) last week and are led by RB Sama (225, 5.6) who had a big 77-yd TD run last week. ISU has covered the L/2 games as DD chalk and we like them to do that once again here as it is tough to play in Ames at night time.

**OKLAHOMA ST by 6 over West Virginia** - Since 2015 Okla St is 8-1 SU/ATS against WVU. Last season the game was tied 27-27 mid 4Q before OSU pulled away with 3 td's incl two long td runs by RB Ollie Gordon. This season Okla St has dropped their F/2 Big 12 games incl last week where they went to Kansas St (+5.5) and lost 42-20 as we picked up a 5★ winner on Kansas St for our Sept Game of the Month!! Okla St isn't getting great production from RB Gordon (312, 3.6) and after a strong 1Q last week (72 yds on 9 carries) was limited the rest of the game (knee) but appears to be good to go. WVU is off a bye and 2 weeks ago got a huge comeback win vs Kansas as they trailed 28-17 4Q but won it 32-28. WVU has a great run game led by RB's White and Donaldson, plus QB Greene is a good runner and they face an Okla St run defense allowing 204 (5.3) incl allowing 300 (8.8) to KSt last week. Okla St does have a strong OL (1 sk allowed in 215 pass att) and QB Bowman is hitting 60% (1559, 12-6 ratio) and WVU does have the #107 pass defense as they have allowed a 9-1 ratio. This should be a close game and we'll lean slightly with the home team who is 0-2 in B12 play and needs a conf win here.

**UCONN by 21 over Temple** - Old AAC and Big East foes face off again. Temple leads the series 14-6 and since 2001 are 9-5 SU/12-2 ATS. Last met in '19 and Temple (-27') won 49-17. Temple's two QB's that have attempted a pass this year are game time decisions (check status) and the backups haven't played a snap of college football before. LW vs Buffalo, UConn (-6) had the +339 yd edge and were +16 FD in a dominate 47-3 win. Temple (+12') got held to their lowest rushing total since '17 (-5) and were outgained by 270 yds in a 42-14 blowout loss to Army. Temple offense avg's 299 ypg and are being held 91 ypg less than what their opponents allow on average. Drayton is 3-9 as a HD while Mora is 11-4 as at home. With the uncertainty at QB and the non-impressive play from the Owls we are going with UConn to win by 3 td's.

**TEXAS A&M by 7 over Missouri** - Battle of ranked SEC teams. Mizzou is 7-3 SU/6-4 ATS vs A&M since 2002 but A&M won the last meeting 35-14 (-11) in '21. Mizzou is fresh off a bye. They needed OT to beat Vandy two weeks ago. A&M is 4-1 after beating Arkansas 21-17 (-6) but they were outgained 379-297. QB Marcel Reed has a 6-0 ratio and is their #2 rusher with 230 (5.5). Mizzou enters 4-0 but their two wins over FBS teams (BC & Vandy) are by a combined 9 points. Elko's D is holding foes 85 ypg below their average and they've held their last 3 foes to 100 rush ypg or less. Mizzou's D is allowing just 219 ypg and they've held foes 56 ypg below their average. A&M is 34-9 SU at home since '18 while Mizzou is just 6-13 SU on the road under Drinkwitz. The home crowd is the difference here and we have A&M by a touchdown.

**James Madison by 13 over ULM** - First mtg. JMU is off to a 4-0 start under 1st year HC Chesney and in their last two games have put up 611 yds vs UNC two weeks ago and last week 522 yds and 63 pts vs Ball St. ULM is off to their first 3-1 start since 2014 as they are off a 13-9 win at Troy. ULM is under 1st year HC Vincent and in their 3 wins are allowing just 272 ypg and 10 ppg, but on offense are only putting up 248 ypg and 20 ppg. ULM's OLine has only allowed 4 sacks in 4 games but here face a tough JMU Dline that has 12 sacks in 4 games. ULM is 8-4 ATS since 2021 as a home underdog and have 1 outright upset this season, beating UAB (+11) 32-6. JMU is facing the #91 pass defense of ULM and QB Barnett is hitting 65% with a 12-1 ratio and is also the #1 rusher (263, 6.4). While JMU is the superior team, they do have Coastal Carolina on deck next Thursday, and this is a much bigger game for ULM and the line is over two td's.

**Louisiana by 21 over SOUTHERN MISS** - Since 1999 SMiss is 7-0 SU/ATS against LA. More recently in '22 here SMiss (+1) was outgained 439-339 but were +2 TO's and won 39-24. Last season no team led by more than 7 points and SMiss (+10) got the 34-31 win in OT. It's been a tough start to the season for SMiss as they have 3 losses to FBS teams all by 25+ points. Last week they were -263 yds and -5 TO's in a 44-7 loss at Jax St. LA on the other hand are 3-1 this season and just upset Wake Forest 41-38. QB Woodriddle is hitting 69% with a 9-3 ratio and they have a trio of RB's all rushing for 6.8 ypc or better. The pass D is allowing 70% on the season but overall LA is allowing just 318 ypg. Since 2021 SMiss is 0-4 SU/ATS as a DD home underdog, losing by an average of 20 points. LA has the big edge on offense (#55 vs #128) and on ST's (#13 vs #133) and we like the Cajuns here by 3 td's!

**NEBRASKA by 7 over Rutgers** - Nebraska is undefeated in this series but is just 2-3 ATS while the under is 4-1. Last met in '22, Nebraska (-3) was down 13-0 at half but shutout the Knights in the 2H and scored two td's in a 14-13 road win. Last met in Lincoln in '17, a 27-17 Nebraska (-12) winner. Rutgers is 4-0 first time s/ '12. Last Friday night the Knights (-1) hosted Washington were actually outgained 521-299 but thanks for UW missing 3 fg's Rutgers pulled out the 21-18 win. Nebraska has their best start (4-1) to a season since '16. Last week, the Huskers (-10) played in their road openers at Purdue. They were tied at 0 at H but scored on three straight possessions and had an interception td return to win 28-10. Rutgers HC Schiano is 12-5-1 ATS as an AD in his second stint here while Neb HC Rhule is 47-27 ATS vs conference foes. Nebraska is holding teams to 274 ypg but Rutgers is avg'ing 428 ypg of offense. Our line is at 7 and both teams have been impressive so we will see how the line closes as the week goes.

**South Alabama by 7 over ARKANSAS ST** - Since 2019 SAla is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS against Ark St. Last season SAla (-13') led 14-3 HT and led 21-6 into the 4Q but a late Ark St td gave them the backdoor cover. Ark St is off a bye and prior to that lost their last 2 games, but they were to a pair of top 20 teams in Michigan (28-18 loss) and Iowa St (52-7 loss) but prior to that won by just 4 and 3 points to open the season. SAla is off a 42-10 loss at LSU (-334 yds) but 2 weeks ago went to App St on a Thur and were up 28-7 HT and won 48-14 with 320 rush yds (7.4). Ark St was 3-1 SU/ATS a year ago as an SBC home dog and are in a good situation here off a bye, but Ark St's defense is allowing foes to gain 52 ypg above their season average (#115 FBS), are allowing 234 rush ypg (6.0) and QB Raynor is hitting just 54% with a 3-5 ratio while they face SAla QB Lopez (64%, 10-0 ratio) and RB Fluff Bothwell (376, 8.0) and an offense putting up 469 ypg. We'll take the Jags by a touchdown on the road in this one.

**Usc by 6 over MINNESOTA** - USC leads the series 6-1-1 but have not met since 2011. Second Big 10 road trip for the Trojans as they were gashed for 290 yard on the ground two weeks ago at Michigan in a 27-24 (-4) loss. LW USC trailed 21-10 at half but had the 264-204 yards edge. The Trojans scored on three straight possessions then capped it off with an interception TD to win their first Big-10 game vs Wisconsin, 38-21 (-14'). Minn (+10) trailed 24-3 in the 3Q but cameback to make it a 27-24 game w/1:37 left, Minn covered the onside but it was called back due to offsides leading Mich to recover the retry to end the game. USC HC Riley is 8-18-1 ATS as a road favorite. Minnesota's defense has been great holding opponents to just 227 ypg and 137 below their season average. USC has a showdown with Penn St on deck so we like to Gophers to keep it close.

**WASHINGTON by 6 over Michigan** - Rematch of last years National Championship. Michigan (-5) was only up 20-13 mid-way through the 4th but then scored two TDs on back-to-back drives to win the Title. Both teams have new head coaches and Michigan returns 7 starters while Washington returns just 6. Previous meeting was here in '21, Washington (+6') were gashed for 343 yds on the ground in a 31-10 loss. Washington has held all five foes this year to a season low in yards (153 yds below their ssn AVG) and QB Rogers has a 10-0 ratio. Michigan has benefitted from back-to-back close wins but are just 1-4 ATS on the year. LW Michigan (-10) was up 24-3 entering the 4th but Minnesota's comeback fell short in a 27-24 win. Washington (+1') outgained Rutgers 521-299 but missed 3 FG's in the game falling 21-18. Michigan being an underdog comes to no surprise as Husky Stadium hasn't seen a Washington loss in the last 17 tries so we look for the Huskies to get the big revenge win at home.

**OHIO ST by 21 over Iowa** - Ohio St has won 16 of last 19 (12-6-1 ATS). Last meeting Iowa (+29') threw an INT with 3:25 left in the 1H (26-10) then were shutout in a 54-10 blowout loss. Ohio St has the slight defensive edge (#1 vs #11) but a solid offensive edge (#2 vs #54). The Hawkeyes are coming off a bye and RB Kaleb Johnson has rushed for at least 100 yards and two TDs every game this season. The Hawkeye offense has looked better than year's past avg 398 ypg. Ohio St (-23') were in East Lansing last week and outgained the Spartans 483-246 in a 38-7 win. The Buckeyes are holding their opponents to 2-9 yards below their ssn avg. Both teams comined to be 7-1 to the over this year and in this series it is 6-2. Ohio St has a big matchup at Oregon next week so we will keep this right by the line.

**SAN DIEGO ST by 3 over Hawaii** - SDSt has won 4 straight over Hawaii (2-1-1 ATS). Last season the Aztecs (-6) led 17-0 2Q, then trailed 24-20 3Q but came back to win 41-34 despite being -102 yds (+3 TO's). The Aztecs are off to a 1-3 start, with their lone win coming against an FCS team in the opener. SDSt is only avg'g 183 pass ypg (55%) and their best playmaker on offense is RB Cooper (474, 4.9). SDSt is also allowing foes to gain 40 ypg above their season average (#108 FBS). Hawaii has 2 wins vs a pair of FCS teams and have losses to UCLA and Sam Houston. QB Schager has an 8-5 ratio (61%) but Hawaii has only ran for 96 rush ypg (3.9). Their defense is allowing just 306 ypg but have only faced the #132 schedule. It is rough to find a big edge for either team in this matchup and we'll call for SDSt by a fg, which is right near the line.

**PENN ST by 34 over UCLA** - First meeting since 1968. First Big-10 road game for the Bruins were they were 3-5 SU/ATS in the PAC-12. Penn St is coming off a home win in their conference opener. The Nittany Lions (-18) were tied at 7 1H but then shut out Illinois, holding them to 34 yards on the ground in a 21-7 win. This is UCLA's third straight game vs a ranked opponent (2-0 ATS). Prior to there matchup two weeks ago the Bruins were not a Double Digit dog since '20. Last week, UCLA (+25) were outgained 431-172 and -16 FD's but only held the Ducks to 6 second half points, in a 34-13 loss. ## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Baltimore over CINCINNATI** - Since 2019 BAL is 7-4 SU (6-5 ATS) against their AFC North foe and last season BAL won & covered both meetings. CIN QB Burrow faced the Ravens twice LY but was inj'd in their game in BAL last Nov. CIN got their first win of the season in CAR last week 34-24 with QB Burrow throwing for 232 yds & 2 td's. BAL stomped BUF last week on Sun Night 35-10 as the Ravens ran for 271 yds (8.0). Against the run this season CIN is allowing 146 (4.4) but BAL's rush attack (220, 6.4) is picking up steam with QB Jackson and RB Henry. BAL is also allowing just 58 rush ypg (3.0) and they have 13 sacks on the season. CIN's defense did struggle to slow down WAS and last week allowed CAR to gain 375 yds. CIN was also just 1-5 ATS vs the AFC North LY & BAL is 10-1 ATS since 2020 when favored by 3 pts or less. BAL could easily be 4-0 with 2 close losses and are taking care of the ball and playing their best ball heading into this divisional matchup and we like the Ravens by 2 scores. **FORECAST: Baltimore by 13**

**3★ Buffalo over HOUSTON** - Buffalo enters this game off their first loss of the season as they allowed 427 yds in a 35-10 loss at BAL. HOU got their 3rd win of the ssn last week, but needed a late td to get by JAX 24-20. HOU WR Diggs will be out to prove something vs his former team but BUF is only allowing 165 pass ypg. HOU does have issues on the OL (14 sks) and are the most penalized team in the NFL through 4 gms (12 penalties LW) and BUF has a good pass rush. BUF couldn't stop the run last week, but HOU doesn't have the same rushing attack and the Texans have yet to cover a game in '24, with their wins coming by 2, 4 and 6 points to the Colts, Jags and Bears. BUF takes care of the ball, as they have just 2 TO's through 4 games. BUF is also 8-2 ATS in games where there are a 3 point favorite or less and we like QB Allen (69%, 7-0 ratio) and BUF to rebound off a loss and get the win in what is by far HOU's toughest game yet. **FORECAST: Buffalo by 10**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ WASHINGTON over Cleveland** - Through 4 weeks no team has been a bigger surprise than the Commanders, who are 3-1 and QB Daniels is the talk of the NFL as he is hitting 82% (3-1 ratio) and has ran for 218 yds (4.7). CLE dropped to 1-3 last week after a loss at Las Vegas where the offense put up only 241 yds and for the season have yet to top 300 yards in ANY game. The OLine for CLE also is an issue as they are missing several key starters and have allowed 19 sks in 4 gms. CLE QB Watson is hitting 62% (4-3 ratio) but CLE leads the NFL in drops and WR Cooper has 6 in 4 gms. CLE's D has played well, allowing just 299 ypg and giving up just 176 pass ypg (59%) but have faced a softer schedule. CLE is just 3-7-1 ATS as an away dog since '22 and with CLE facing so many inj's we like the Commaders to keep rolling with a win here. **FORECAST: Washington by 10**

## OTHER PLAYS

**Tampa Bay at ATLANTA - TNF** - Since 2020 TB is 6-2 SU (4-4 ATS) against ATL. Last season on the road TB pulled the outright upset 29-25 (+2). Both teams enter here off a win as ATL won 26-24 vs NOLA with a GW 58-yd fg despite getting outgained 366-315 while TB QB Mayfield threw for 347 yds and 2 td's in a 33-16 win over Philly. The ATL pass defense is allowing 73% and Mayfield is hitting 71% this season with an 8-2 ratio. TB does have a bit of a shaky OL, as they have allowed 15 sacks, but the Falcons pass rush has just 4 sacks this season. ATL is only rushing for 103 ypg (4.6) but could get their run game going vs a TB defense allowing 132 rush ypg (5.0) and the Bucs pass D is allowing 65% on the season but QB Cousins has just a 4-4 ratio. **Call the office on Thursday after Noon EST for the Marquee Winner!**

**† Minnesota by 7 over NY Jets** - London. The Jets travel here off a loss as they were upset 10-9 (-8) at home vs DEN in a rainstorm where they only managed 248 yds and allowed 5 sacks. MIN heads into this game as one of the 2 remaining unbeaten NFL teams. They went up 28-0 on rival GB last week in the 2Q before the Packers stormed back and nearly completed the comeback, with MIN winning 31-29. The Vikings pass rush has collected 17 sacks in 4 sacks and the Jets OL looks like it could be an issue. NYJ is also struggling to run the ball (92, 2.7) and MIN shuts the run down (75, 3.8). NYJ has only allowed 121 pass yds the L/2 gms but that was vs DEN and NE, here they face WR's Addison and Jefferson and MIN QB Darnold has an 8-2 ratio (68%). MIN has been playing well and the Jets have underperformed, so we'll side with the 4-0 team here. **CHICAGO by 7 over Carolina** - These two teams are linked after CAR traded with CHI to take QB Young and it helped CHI land QB Williams. CHI is off a 24-18 win vs LAR while CAR lost at home to Cincy 34-24. CHI QB Williams could find success here vs a CAR pass D allowing 71% completions and their pass rush has just 5 sks in 4 gms. CHI got their run game going last week (131, 4.7). CAR has looked better with QB Dalton starting, but he faces a tough Bears D that is allowing just 296 ypg and are tied for 3rd in the NFL with 8 takeaways. Carolina is just 2-8-1 ATS as an away dog, and with CHI's defense playing well, this could be a game where their offense starts to click and we saw glimpses of that last week with the run game. CAR has allowed the most points in the NFL through 4 games (129). CHI is 2-0 ATS as a HF this season and we like the Bears to pick up their 3rd home win of the season by a touchdown.

**JACKSONVILLE by 6 over Indianapolis** - JAX sits at 0-4 on the season, but welcome the Colts to town, who have not won a game here since back in 2014 (0-9 SU/ATS)! In fact the last 5 meetings here JAX has won by an avg of 16 pts! IND got their 2nd straight win last week vs PIT where QB Flacco came in and IND gained 128 yds above what PIT was allowing on the season. The JAX run game showed signs of life last week (158, 6.6) but QB Lawrence is hitting just 53% and avg'g just 182 pass ypg. The Colts D allowed 404 ypg to PIT last week, who came in avg'g just 289 ypg. IND's pass D is allowing 235 ypg and is giving up 69%. Lawrence has played well vs IND, hitting 71% with a 9-2 ratio in 6 starts. We'll side with JAX to get win #1 of the season here. **NEW ENGLAND by 3 over Miami** - NE is just 1-5 SU/0-6 ATS against their AFC East foes from Miami since 2021. However, MIA is struggling to get anything going on offense without Tua at QB, as they have put up 389 yards and 15 points combined the past 2 weeks. While the NE offense is putting up only 239 ypg, they do have a solid defense who won't have to worry about the offensive weapons in MIA's lineup. MIA's OL has also been an issue, allowing 13 sacks in 4 games and the Dolphins are only rushing for 98 ypg (3.7). Miami has been solid on defense (282 ypg) and are only allowing 163 pass ypg. This will be an ugly offensive game and points will be at a premium, but after watching MIA's lack of offense the L/2 gms we'll lean slightly with NE here.

**Las Vegas by 1 over DENVER** - This is a series the Raiders have dominated of late, winning 9 of the last 10 meetings SU/ATS. Vegas is 2-2 despite their offense only avg'g 289 ypg and their run game avg'g just 76 ypg (3.6) but did have a good performance (152, 5.2) vs a solid CLE defense a week ago. DEN won last week at NYJ despite just 186 total yds and 10 pts. Their defense is playing well, allowing just 257 ypg and 14 ypg with 16 sks, but DEN QB Nix still only has a 1-4 ratio and the run game is putting up just 106 (4.1). LV proved it could win last week without their top stars in WR Adams and DE Crosby and got their run game going to take some pressure off QB Minshew. We expect a lower-scoring game and like LV's win streak over DEN to continue.

**SAN FRANCISCO by 10 over Arizona** - SF has won and covered each of the past 4 meetings between these NFC West foes & have won those games by an average of 22 points. SF got back to .500 on the season with a 30-13 win over NE last week and could be getting some key players back from inj like WR Smauel and TE Kittle. ARZ dropped to 1-3 this ssn with a 42-14 loss vs WAS last week, where they allowed 449 yards. The ARZ offense has been held to under 300 yards in 3 of 4 games and SF's defense is still playing well, holding teams to just 295 ypg and only allowing 96 rush ypg (4.1). SF QB Purdy is hitting 69% with a 5-2 ratio and despite losing RB McCaffrey, backup Jordan Mason has filled in well (447, 4.9). ARZ does allow 147 rush ypg (4.4) including 216 (5.8) a week ago and their pass D is giving up 79% completions! We like the 49ers to continue their dominance over ARZ and win by two scores here.

**Green Bay by 3 over LA RAMS** - GB got their QB back a week ago and Jordan Love had an up & down performance, throwing for 389 yards and 4 td's, but also threw 3 int's as well. The Rams offense gave them a chance last week in CHI, but ultimately LAR lost 24-18 as they were -2 TO's. The Rams are allowing 220 pass ypg and 73% completions! They also only have 7 sacks, while the OL has allowed 13 sacks in 4 games. GB does have a solid pass rush (13 sks) and they have a strong OLine (6 sks all'd) and their run game puts up 175 ypg (5.4) while the Rams give up 166 ypg (5.0) on the ground. The Rams have a bye week on deck to try and finally get healthy, while the Packers fought back from 28-0 down last week to nearly win. We think GB rides that 2H momentum from last week to get the win in LA, but have this one finishing at the line.

**SEATTLE by 10 over NY Giants** - The Giants travel to the West Coast on extra rest after playing last Thur at home vs DAL where they lost 20-15. SEA is off short rest after playing on Mon Night at DET where they had a 516-389 yd edge but were -2 TO's. SEA QB Smith threw for 383 yds against DET and the Giants are allowing opposing QB's to hit 73%. NYG could be without rookie stud WR Nabers after he suffered a concussion last week. SEA is only allowing 168 pass ypg and their pass rush has 14 sacks on the season. SEA also got back RB Walker last week and they ran for 133 yards (7.0) opening up the pass game even more. If Nabers can't go, this Giants offense takes a huge step back, and SEA at home will ride their balanced offensive attack and their strong pass rush to a two-score home win.

**Dallas at PITTSBURGH - SNF** - These two teams have faced off 3 times in the Super Bowl. DAL heads into this trip off extra rest, having played last Thur in New York. DAL will likely be without two of their top pass rushers in DE Lawrence and OLB Parsons. PIT's offense topped 400 yds for just the 3rd time since the start of '21 last week at Indy, but were -2 TO's and lost 27-24. PIT QB Fields is playing well, hitting 71%, but PIT is dealing with a ton of inj's to their OL and they allowed 4 sacks last week. The PIT defense is allowing just 262 ypg/13 ppg and are holding teams to just 87 rush ypg (3.7). DAL is more of a passing team (256 ypg, 64%) as they are only running for 75 ypg (2.8). DAL QB Prescott has the edge in Prime Time experience, but PIT has the coaching edge. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for the Marquee Winner!**

**New Orleans at KANSAS CITY - MNF** - NOLA comes into this game on a 2 game skid, and their offense has taken a step back after their fast start. KC is just one of two 4-0 teams, but did lose WR Rice to a knee injury, which hurts their passing attack.
