4★ Texas Over Oklahoma- Game is in Dallas. Teams have met 115 times, with Texas holding a 62-48-5 SU lead. Dating back to 2013 Texas has only won 3 times SU, but are 7-1 ATS incl 3 outright upsets in that span. LY Texas (+10) had the FD edge 25-21, but OU outgained Texas 511-310 (OU -2 TO's and stopped on downs) & Texas covered late with a TD to make it a 34-27 final. Last week both teams might have been looking ahead as OU (-7) went on the road to Iowa St & lost 37-30 while Texas (-10) fumbled at the 1-yd line late and lost to TCU 33-31. In the L/5 mtgs Tex's DEF has all'd 548 ypg & 38 ppg to OU and this season the Texas DEF has all'd 449 ypg in Big 12 play, while OU's DEF is all'g 409 ypg in Big 12 play. OU QB Rattler is hitting 73% for 977 yds (10-4 ratio) but now faces a rival for first time while Texas QB Ehlinger is a veteran of the rivalry & in 4 career gms vs OU has thrown for 1,151 yds (62%, 5-1) and has ran for 215 yds & 8 td. OU comes in just 3-9 ATS as Big 12 chalk the LZY & are were just 1-4 ATS vs ranked foes LY. Six of the L/7 mtgs have been decided by 8 pts or less & we think this is another close game, but we'll lean with Texas as HC Herman is great as an underdog, going 16-4 with 11 outright upsets! **FORECAST: † Texas by 6**

3★ South Carolina over VANDERBILT- SC has won 11 straight and covered 5 straight in this series and won last year 24-7, outgaining the 'Dores 440-189. Both teams enter 0-2. We picked up a 3.5★ winner on OVER 57 in SC's 38-24 loss at Florida last week. The Gamecocks held a +7 FD edge, were only outgained 348-329 and were SOD at the UF4 late 4Q. Vanderbilt was 3 td dogs last week vs LSU. They only trailed 21-7 at half but were shutout in the 2H and were outgained 498-266, losing 41-7. The 'Dores have failed to top 300 yards in both games and are -175 ypg. SC averages 340 ypg and is -32 ypg. Vandy is just 2-9 as a home dog and with Muschamp on the hot seat it's imperative that the Gamecocks win this emphatically. **FORECAST: South Carolina by 20**

3★ TCU over Kansas St- TCU plays their 3rd straight gm in Texas, while KSt is on the road for the 2nd time in 3 weeks. LY TCU (-3) outgained KSt 366-266 incl 228 rush yds, but KSt blk'd a punt (led to short td drive) and scored the GW TD with 2:45 left to win 24-17 & pull outright upset. TCU is off a road upset at Texas 33-31 (4★ Power Sweep Winner!), while KSt took down Tex Tech at home. However KSt senior QB Thompson had to leave the game after a big hit and had a sling on his throwing arm in the 2H (status for this game unknown) and true frosh Will Howard was the replacement. TCU QB Duggan made 1st start last wk vs Texas & hit 66% for 231 yds, but also ran for 2 td's and now faces a KSt pass def that is all'g 328 ypg (69.5%) on the season. KSt all'g 492 ypg this ssn, but the DEF has forced 7 TO's already this ssn. TCU is just 1-4 ATS in the L/5 meetings and are also just 1-4 ATS since '17 as a Big 12 home favorite. Meanwhile KSt is 3-1 ATS as a Big 12 road dog under HC Klieman incl getting the outright upset of Oklahoma 2 wks ago. However, the injury to QB Thompson could have a big impact on this game if he doesn't play & the KSt defense hasn't exactly been stout to start the season. We'll lean with the Frogs for the 2nd straight week. **FORECAST: TCU by 20**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Ncst (+) over VIRGINIA - The underdog has owned this series with 6 upsets in the last 9 meetings. The home team is 7-2 SU/ATS. Ncst won the last meeting in '18 35-21 (-6). We used the Wolfpack on these pages for a 2★ play as 2 td dogs last week. QB Leary returned after missing the first 2 games and threw for 336 and 4 td's including the GW td pass with :23 left. Ncst's win at +540 was one of 4 Big Dog Money Line Winners we gave out (Call 1-800-654-3448 for Big Dogs, just \$9!!!). We also picked up a 3★ Totals win over the OVER in UVA's 41-23 (+28) loss at Clemson. Ncst looked much better with Leary at QB but the 'Hoos are at home and Ncst's got some injury issues on defense. The dog as owned this series which has us leaning with Ncst but we won't call for the upset. **FORECAST: VIRGINIA by 3**

THURSDAY OCTOBER 8TH

Tulane at HOUSTON - Houston leads the series 17-7 SU, but Tulane have won 3 of the L/4 ATS. After having 5 games already cancelled or postponed, Houston is finally playing their opener. Houston brings back 19 st'rs and QB Tune got valuable exp LY after being thrown into fire mid-season and he will have the top 5 receivers back from LY. Houston gave up 468 ypg & 34 ppg a season ago, but they have 9 st'rs back and should improve. A ssn ago Houston led 28-14 vs Tulane at the half (373-161), but were held to just 160 yds & 3 pts and lost 38-31 (Tulane 350 yds, 24 pts in 2H). Tulane is off an actual bye week, but in their last game they trailed Southern Miss 14-0 in 1Q, but came back to blow them out 66-24 as the Green Wave ran for 430 yds! Houston was just 1-4 ATS LY under Holgorsen, but Tulane is just 2-6 dating back to '17 as an away dog, but do have a 3 GUB edge over the Cougars! Louisville at GEORGIA TECH - The last time these two met was in '18 when the Jackets shredded Louisville with their triple option for a 66-31 (-5) win. Both teams enter off a bye. Georgia Tech has lost their last 2 games since upsetting FSU in their opener. Prior to their bye they lost 37-20 as 7 pt chalk at Syracuse but they did finish with a 453-357 yard edge. Turnovers have been a major theme for the Jackets. True Frosh QB Sims has a 5-8 ratio and the Jackets are -7 TO's in their 2 losses. L'ville has also lost their last 2. Prior to their bye the Cardinals were held to 223 yds by Pitt in a 23-20 (+3) loss. QB Cunningham took a beating from the vaunted Pitt Dline which resulted in him leaving on a stretcher in the 4Q. The Cardinals have two experienced backup QB's if Cunningham can't go. GT is 0-5-1 as a home dog under Collins. We won a Friday Night Marquee winner in '18 on this game, let's see if we can work some more Friday magic here!

SATURDAY OCTOBER 10TH

KENTUCKY by 10 over Mississippi St - The home team is 5-0 SU/ATS in this series. Miss St is 9-2 SU/7-3-1 ATS vs Kentucky. LY the Bulldogs jumped to a 21-3 2Q lead and KY was ply'g with a banged up backup QB. Miss St held on for a 28-13 win as 6 pt chalk. The 'Cats have held the yardage edge each of their first 2 games yet they are 0-2 for the first time since '16. KY led Ole Miss by 14 2Q but missed a fg, fumbled at the goal line after their RB was tripped while taunting defenders then they missed a PAT in OT to lose 42-41 (-6). Last week Miss St was off their big upset win over revamped LSU. The Bulldogs outgained Arkansas 400-275 but QB Costello threw 3 int's and RB Hill left early with an injury as Miss St was upset 21-14 (-17). The Bulldogs are allowing just 72 (1.9) rush ypg while KY avg 277 (5.8) rush ypg. You have to worry about Kentucky's pass D after allowing 320 yds & 83% completions last week but we figure HC Stoops brother Bob can give him some tips on stopping the Air Raid. Miss St is 1-6 as an AD.

Duke by 5 over SYRACUSE - Duke is 2-0 all-time in the Carrier Dome including in '14 when the #22 Blue Devils won 27-10 (-4). Last year Duke was 10' pt chalk but trailed 14-6 at half then Cuse got 3 td's on drives of 2, 42 & 15 yards to blow the game open, winning 49-6. Cuse enters fresh off a bye after their 37-20 upset over GTech where they were outgained 453-357 but were +4 TO's. Duke is 0-4 after last week's 38-31 (+12) loss at home vs VTech. The Blue Devils are -64 ypg while Cuse is -176. QB Brice had his most memorable moment vs Cuse in '18 when he relieved an injured QB Lawrence at Clemson and led a td drive that essentially saved the Tigers season. He threw for a ssn high 271 last week but has a 3-7 ratio on the season. Both teams are struggling but HC Cutcliffe is 7-3-1 as an AF and Cuse's win over GT was deceiving so we will give the Blue Devils a slight lean.

COLLEGE MARQUEES!!!!!!

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Pittsburgh by 8 over BOSTON COLLEGE - Pitt is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS in this series but the Panthers are out for revenge after losing on Senior day last year 26-19 (-8). BC is off a closer than expected loss vs North Carolina. The Eagles never led and did trail 14-3 1Q but QB Jurkovec was impressive, throwing for 313 and 2 td's including his last one with :45 left but failed on the 2 pt conv (ret'd by NC) and BC lost 26-22 (+14). We went against Pitt as 2 td chalk on these pages last week and picked up a 2★ winner on Ncst who got a late td from QB Leary (336, 4 td's in first action of ssn). Pitt never led despite Kenny Pickett throwing for a career high 411 yds and Ncst got the GW td with :23 left. Pitt has a large defensive edge and their strength is their DLine which has 15 sacks. BC has 4 OLine starters back but surprisingly have given up 11 sacks in 3 games. HC Narduzzi is 18-12-1 ATS vs ACC foes, 5-2 as an AF and is 11-6 ATS off a SU loss.

USF by 7 over East Carolina - Going back to 2002 USF is 9-1 SU/7-2-1 ATS against E.Carolina. LY USF outgained ECU by over 200 yds (525-324, ECU KR TD to start the game) and the Bulls won 45-20. USF is off a 28-7 loss to Cincy, where 3 different QB's had at least 6 pass attempts, but the USF offense had just 291 yds & scored 7 pts. ECU is coming off a 20-pt loss to Georgia St, where the Pirates offense totaled 292 yds (3 int's, 4 sks all'd) and QB Ahlers is hitting just 54% with a 3-4 ratio. USF RB Johnny Ford could have a big day against an ECU run defense that has allowed 236 ypg (5.6) so far this season. ECU also has not gotten a great pass rush this season, as they have 0 sacks through 2 gms. USF's pass defense has played well this ssn, giving up just 125 pass ypg (50.8% comp allowed) but their run DEF has been hit for 223 ypg (4.7) and they have only 2 sks through 3 games. USF was only a favorite 3 times LY (1 gm was vs ECU) and they were 3-0 in that role, while ECU was 0-3 ATS last year as a single-digit dog. Neither one of these teams excite us, but we'll lean with the home squad by a TD.

Clemson by 10 over Miami, FL - Clemson gets their toughest ACC test in quite some time. The Tigers have won the last 2 meetings by a combined 96-3 including the '17 ACC Title game. The visitor is 5-0 ATS in the series. Miami enters fresh off a bye after crushing rival Florida St 52-10 (-10). All 3 of Miami's wins have been by double-digits. We used a 3★ LP Totals play on OVER 55 in Clemson's 41-23 (-28) win over Virginia. QB Lawrence has a 7-0 ratio. Clemson has surprisingly given up 303 ypg but QB's are only completing 50% and they have 13 sacks. Miami's revamped up tempo offense under OC Lashlee and QB King will give the Tigers defense their biggest challenge of the season. King is hitting 67% with a 6-0 ratio and RB Harris averages 8.2 ypc. Miami has only given up 3 sacks. After going on a 19-4-1 ATS run, Clemson now has 3 straight non-covers vs FBS foes. HC Diaz is 4-0 as an underdog including 3 outright upsets. We won't call for the 'Canes to win but we definitely think they can keep this within 2 td's.

NORTH CAROLINA by 3 over Virginia Tech - VT is 13-3 SU and has covered 6 of the last 7 in this series but the last 2 have been decided by 2 & 3 points with NC holding the yards edge in both. The home team is on a 6-2 ATS run including 3 straight covers. NC led 14-3 1Q last week vs BC but QB Howell only threw for 225 and the Heels struggled to stop BC's pass game in the 2H of their 26-22 (-14) win. VT also failed to cover as DD road chalk thanks to costly TO's including a fumbled punt recovered in the EZ. RB Herbert had 208 rush yds along with an 83 yd KR. QB Hooker could be back this week after sitting out the first 2 games due to Covid issues. He was available last week but hadn't practiced enough to play. VT has 13 sacks in their first 2 games and NC allowed 4 sacks vs BC. NC is only allowing 54 (2.0) rush ypg but both teams they've faced have struggled to run the ball and VT has topped 300 rush 2 straight games. The Hokies have been short handed the last 2 weeks due to Covid but could have many guys back. VT is 4-1 as a HD and we will take the Hokies to keep it closer than expected. Last year we won our Totals GOY on UNDER 44 in VTech vs Pitt (28-0). Could we look at another Hokies game for our first Totals GOM?

GEORGIA by 7 over Tennessee - UGA has won the last 2 by a combined 81-26 but Tenn only trailed 29-14 4Q but both years they were within 2 td's in the 4Q. Tenn enters off a 35-12 (-11) win over MO. The Vols got former UGA OG Cade Mays eligible prior to the game which helped ignite their Oline to rush for 232 (4.5). Tenn did only finish with a 422-344 yd edge but were +11 FD's. UGA dominated Aub in the trenches in their 27-6 (-7) win. The Dawgs held a 442-216 yd edge and QB Stetson Bennett looked good in his first start, throwing for 240 yds and 1 td. The Vols currently own the nation's longest win streak at 8 and they've covered 7 of those. UGA has the best defense in the country, but Tenn is much more competitive than the Vols team the Dawgs beat last year and we will call for the Vols to keep this closer than expected.

IOWA ST by 10 over Texas Tech - Texas Tech leads all-time series 11-7 SU, but Iowa St has won the L/4 mtgs SU & ATS. LY ISU (-7) went to TTech and won 34-24 (560-407) as and RB Hall ran for 183 yds (2 td) and QB Purdy threw for 378 yds (3 td). ISU is off a big upset win at home against Oklahoma (37-30) where RB Hall ran for 139 yds (5.0) and 2 td's. TTech was at KSt last week and while they had the yard edge (471-404) and FD edge (27-20) they lost 31-21 (2 missed FG's, blk'd punt and INT). ISU's pass DEF has all'd 350 ypg in Big 12 play, and could face TTech QB Bowman (778, 66%, 7-4), but he left early last week after getting hit low, but bkp QB Colombi came in & hit 30/42 for 244 (2-1). TTech's OLine has only all'd 1 sack this season, but face an ISU defense with 11 sks on the year. TTech will also have their hands full with ISU RB Hall, as their run defense has all'd 206 ypg (4.6) to Big 12 foes this ssn. TTech is 1-3 ATS as a Big 12 dog & are just 2-5 ATS off a SU loss under HC Wells. While ISU is a great underdog under HC Campbell (19-9-1 ATS) they are only 2-5 ATS dating back to '17 as a home favorite. There might be some hangover after their marquee win last week, and we will cut our lean off on ISU at 10 points.

Alabama by 14 over MISSISSIPPI - Nick Saban gets to reunite with his beloved former OC Lane Kiffin. The Tide have won the last 4 meetings though Ole Miss is on a 10-5 ATS series run including LY when they lost 59-31 (+38). Bama flexed their muscles last week beating A&M 52-24 (-18). QB Jones threw for 435 and 4 td's, though Bama did only finish with a +96 yd edge and were actually -3 FD's. Lane Kiffin got his first SEC win at Ole Miss last week by beating Kentucky 42-41 (+6). The Rebels trailed 28-14 3Q were outgained 559-459 but recovered a fumble on the goal line and KY missed a PAT in OT. QB Corral topped 300 pass yards for the 2nd consecutive game under Kiffin. Saban is 20-0 vs former assistants, winning by an average score of 42-15 but there could be some major back door potential with Ole Miss' high powered offense. Bama averages 45 ppg in their first 2 while Ole Miss averages 36 ppg but is giving up 46 ppg and 601 ypg so the OVER could very well be in the mix for our TOTALS GOM!

AUBURN by 13 over Arkansas - Auburn is 3-0 SU/ATS when hosting Arkansas and they've also won 4 straight by an average score of 48-9 (4-0 ATS in those). Sam Pittman has brought some toughness back to Arkansas football and we used them as one of our 4 Big Dog winners last week (Just \$9, call 1-800-654-3448) in their 21-14 (+18) win at Miss St. Auburn was fortunate to win their opener against Kentucky (-60 yds) then got dominated last week at UGA 27-6 (+7) where they were outgained 442-216. QB Nix completed just 51% and the Tigers average just 65 (2.5) rush ypg. Arkansas played UGA much tougher 2 weeks ago when they led 7-5 at half before things got away in a 27 pt loss but they were only -107 yds while Auburn finished -226 vs the Dawgs. Auburn OC Morris knows the Arkansas personnel but Auburn is laying more than 3 td's and we see no reason to think Arkansas can't keep this closer. Auburn is 10-17-1 as a HF including 5-9 vs SEC foes.

LSU by 15 over Missouri - The last time these two met was Ed Orgeron's first game as Interim HC and LSU won 42-7 (-12) in '16. LSU was the least experienced team in the country entering '20 so it was understandable that they lose their opener against Miss St. They bounced back last week to beat Vandy 41-7 (-21) and the Tigers finished with 498-266 yd & 28-17 FD edges. QB Brennan threw for 337 yds and 4 td's. Mizzou are 0-2 under Eli Drinkwitz after LW's 35-12 (+11) loss at Tenn. QB Robinson started but Drinkwitz quickly switched to rF QB Bazalak who threw for 218 and 1 int but the WR's were plagued by drops. LSU is still a young team and despite two blowout losses, Mizzou is only -85 ypg. It's hard to play against Orgeron who is 23-10 ATS vs SEC foes but we have a slight lean on the underdog Missouri Tigers here.

Florida by 2 over TEXAS A&M - The last 2 meetings have been decided by 5 total points with the visitor pulling upsets in both. A&M won the last meeting in '17 19-17 (+2). The Gators beat Johnny Manziel in College Station in '12. Florida is 2-0 after beating South Carolina 38-24 (-17) and the Gamecocks nearly cut it to single digits on their final possession before getting SOD at the UF4. UF only finished with a +19 yard edge and SC had a 25-18 FD edge. A&M was more competitive than their 52-24 (+18) loss at Bama indicates. Kellen Mond threw for 318 yds and the game was tied 14-14 2Q before a pick 6 and a key dropped pass on 4th down led to a late Bama td to end the half up 21. QB Trask has a 10-1 ratio and TE Pitts is a favorite for the Mackey Award with 6 td's in 2 games but Florida is allowing 471 ypg, 65% completions and 328 pass ypg. Fisher was 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS vs UF during his time at FSU. Last week we picked up a 3★ Top Totals Play winner on OVER 57 in Florida's win over South Carolina. We could easily go back to the Gators for our Totals GOM with how their offense is playing.

TROY by 6 over Texas St - As SBC foes Troy holds a 5-0 SU record and a 4-1 ATS record against Texas St. Troy was supposed to play S.Alabama last week but the game was cancelled (positive tests for SAla) and TXSt had a bye week. In last year's matchup, Troy only outgained TXSt 471-416, but won 63-27 as TXSt threw 4 int's and Troy converted all of those INT's into td's incl a pick-six. Troy's last game 2 wks ago was at BYU where they gained just 181 yds and were blown out 48-7, while TXSt has 4 qms under their & nearly upset Boston College 2 wks ago (24-21 loss, held BC to 297 yds). TXSt QB McBride was back 2 wks ago & threw for 229 yds (66%, 2-1) and now faces a Troy pass DEF that gave up 472 yds to BYU. In their F/3 gms TXSt's DEF gave up 496 ypg and do face a solid Troy offense (496 yds vs Mid Tenn). Neither teams OLine's have been strong to start the ssn, as Troy has all'd 8 sks in 2 gms & TXSt has given up 14 sks in 4 gms. Troy was just 1-3 ATS last season as a home favorite and TXSt has already covered twice as an underdog this season.

LIBERTY by 21 over ULM - First meeting. Liberty is off a 28-7 win vs N.Alabama where QB Willis did not play (arm inj, status of presstime is unknown) and bkp QB Ferguson (Maine transfer) started & was just 12/21 for 64 yds (3 td's) while ULM looked good for the 1st time this season, as they nearly upset GS (stopped 1 yd shy of EZ to end game) in a 35-30 loss. ULM ran the ball 53% of the time last ssn (207 ypg & 5.5 ypc) but this ssn are focusing more on the pass (68%) and last week QB Suits threw for 334 yds (through 4 gms 1043 yds, 63%, 6-2) but Liberty has only all'd 171 pass ypg. Liberty RB Mack has 337 yds (6.5) this ssn and if Willis is back for Liberty (253 rush yds, 7.4 ypc) he will be another threat ULM has to try and stop on the ground as the Warhawk defense has all'd 282 rush ypg (5.6). While ULM finally showed us something last week, their DEF is giving up a lot yds & pts and face a Liberty team that is all'g just 281 ypg. We'll lean Liberty as ULM is also just 3-7 ATS as an underdog the L2Y.

BYU by 38 over Utsa - First meeting. BYU is on an absolute tear this season, as they are 3-0 after a 45-14 win vs LTech (513-313) with 111 yds for LTech coming in the 4Q with the outcome already decided. Overall BYU is outscoring their foes 148-24 and their defense is holding foes to 214 ypg. Utsa is off a 21-13 loss to UAB where they did not have QB Frank Harris and only gained 280 yds, but were +3 TO's. The status for Harris this week is unknown as of presstime. Utsa is getting great production from RB McCormick, as he has 527 rush yds (5.9, 4 td) already this ssn. Utsa though is facing arguably the best QB in college football right now not named Trevor Lawrence, as Zach Wilson hit 24/26 this past week for 325 yds (2 td pass, 3 td rush) and for this ssn has 949 pass yds (83%, 6-1 ratio). Utsa's pass defense has given up 285+ pass yds in 3 of their 4 gms this ssn and this is by far their toughest test of the season. With the Roadrunners having to go on the road and deal with the elevation, we have no problem putting a big lean on BYU.

SOUTHERN MISS by 3 over Fau - Last year FAU won 34-17 on Senior Day to clinch the CUSA East. The Both teams feature new head coaches and FAU had QB Robison dismissed in August. We went against the Owls as our Underdog POW as well as a 3★ LPS, picking up a winner as the Owls fell behind 10-0 at half, putting up just 72 yards on 29 plays but rallied to win 21-17

NORTH TEXAS +3 over Charlotte

NORTH TEXAS over Charlotte - Last year was the first ever series meeting and Charlotte pulled out a 39-38 (+4) win, scoring the game winning td with :18 left. We picked up both an Under POW and 3★ LPS with Charlotte last week in their 21-17 (+5) loss at FAU. The 49ers led 10-0 at half, held FAU to 72 1H yards and finished with a +98 yard edge. NT held +46 yd & +5 FD edges last week vs Southern Miss but lost 41-31. NT lost 3 fumbles, gave up an inside kick and as SOD at the SM6. Austin Aune had another impressive performance, throwing for 339 and 2 td's. In 2 games UC has 0 sacks and NT is rushing for 239 (5.0) while only allowing 3 sacks. The Mean Green defense has allowed 572 ypg but should fair much better against Charlotte who only averages 341 and the 49ers defense is allowing 263 (6.3) rush ypg. Last week we went with Charlotte as our Underdog POW and won. This week we will go against the favored 49ers and call for the Mean Green to come up with a cleaner performance and win this by a touchdown.

FORECAST: NORTH TEXAS by 7

(-5). Indiana transfer QB Tronti only completed 50% for 98 yards but also led with 94 rush yds. SMiss took advantage of 3 North Texas TO's last week and won 41-31 (+1), getting interim HC Walden his first win. The Golden Eagles were outgained 483-437. RB Frank Gore Jr rushed for 130 (5.7). SMiss WR Tim Jones (902, 12.4 LY) has missed their last 2 games but could return this week. SMiss was a team that had high expectations and getting a road win should give them confidence and they are 4-0 as a home dog so they are the pick here.

Temple by 6 over NAVY - Temple leads series 8-6 SU, and more recently Temple is 4-1 SU/3-1-1 ATS vs Navy. Temple's season was pushed back because of Covid so this is actually their first game of the 2020 season. Navy last week travelled to Air Force and despite AF not having nearly 40 players (opt outs) the Falcons ran for 369 yds and Navy was -2 TO's in a 40-7 loss. Navy's offense is struggling, as they are avg'g 138 rush yds (3.2 ypc) and they have given up 8 sks in just 38 pass attempts (21%). Temple brings back 7 str's on offense incl QB Russo (2861, 59%, 21-12) and the top RB and top 2 WR's from a season ago. The Temple DEF, which gave up 378 ypg & 26 ppg LY, losses 7 str's & the top 6 overall tk'rs from a year ago. In their L/3 mtgs Temple has held Navy to 191 rush yds (3.8) while the Owls offense has put up 397 ypg & 31 ppg in the L/3 mtgs. While the Owls have not played yet, we cannot trust a Navy squad that despite a 3 GUB edge, is off a terrible loss to an undermanned AF team & are a 24-pt comeback away from an 0-3 start.

Middle Tennessee by 1 over FIU - The home team is 6-1 SU/ATS in this series. MT has won 4 of the last 5 meetings and LY they trailed 17-14 at half before dominating the 2H 36-0, finishing with 471 rush yards. The Blue Raiders enter 0-4 after a 20-17 (+7) loss at WKU. FIU is off a scheduled bye after they only lost at Liberty 36-34 but were outgained 527-304. The Panthers struggled to stop a mobile QB in Liberty's Malik Willis, now they face Asher O'Hara who shredded them for 159 (7.2) last year. FIU is 2-7 as CUSA home chalk. It's hard to imagine Rick Stockstill going 0-5 and we like the matchup here for the Blue Raiders having played 4 games while FIU has only gotten 1 in so we will call for a minor upset.

Louisiana Tech by 13 over UTEP - Going back to 2001 LTech is 10-1 SU against UTEP, but just 5-6 ATS. LY LTech and UTEP were tied 7-7 in the 2Q, but LTech would score 35 straight pts and won 42-21. UTEP is off an actual bye week, and are off to a 3-1 start to the season, though 2 wins are against FCS teams by a comb'd 14 pts. LTech played last Friday at BYU and were blown out 45-14 (outgained 513-313) with 111 yds coming in the 4Q with the game already put away. FCS transfer QB Anthony has 654 pass yds (62%, 10-2) this season for LTech and as a whole LTech's OFF is putting up 412 ypg & 37 ppg. Before their game against ULM (512 yds, 31 pts) the UTEP offense avg'd just 297 ypg & 14 ppg, but LTech's defense has given up 469 ypg including 501 yds to FCS Houston Baptist. The UTEP defense did allow 689 yds & 59 pts to Texas, but in their other 3 gms they held teams to 244 ypg & 11 ppg. UTEP is 1-3 ATS under HC Dimel off a SU win, but LTech is just 3-7 ATS since '16 as a home favorite in CUSA play and we will cut off our lean on the Bulldogs at just under 2 td's.

NOTRE DAME by 24 over Florida St - Notre Dame broke a 3 game series losing streak in '18 when they crushed FSU 42-13 (-16) at home. The 'Noles started Frosh QB Tate Rodemaker last week vs FCS Jacksonville St. Rodemaker had 0 points and threw a Pick-6 in his 4 possessions before HC Norvell switched to dual threat QB Travis and the 'Noles had td's on 6 of their next 7 possessions. Travis threw for 248 and rushed for 48. ND enters fresh off a scheduled bye after having their game vs WF cancelled. The Irish are +153 ypg in their first 2 including a 52-0 (-24) win over USF. We were impressed with Travis last week but it's hard to have much faith in the 'Noles and ND has won their last 7 by 29.6 ypg (6-1 ATS in those). FSU has failed to cover 6 straight and they are 1-5 as double-digit dogs. ND is on an 11-4-1 ATS run while FSU is on an 8-17-2 ATS run.

WKU by 1 over Marshall - Marshall has won the last 3 meetings, all by 7 points or less but WKU is 6-0 ATS in this series. WKU led 23-7 3Q last year before Marshall rallied and won on a 51 yard field goal on the game's final play. WKU got their first win of the season last week, beating Middle Tenn 20-17 (-7). Marshall enters off 2 straight byes. Three weeks ago they pulled an upset as 7 point dogs over App St 17-7. Both teams feature All-CUSA RB's. Marshall's Brenden Knox has 223 (4.8) in 2 games while WKU's Gaej Walker only has 68 (2.7) through 3 games. WKU was an experienced team entering '20, and while they've been disappointing, their loss against Liberty doesn't look so bad now and with some confidence after getting a win under their belt we will call for the 'Toppers to pull the upset. The Herd are just 10-22 as chalk while Helton is 6-2 as an underdog with 5 outright upsets.

LOUISIANA by 6 over Coastal Carolina - Game was orig set to be played on Oct. 17, but Louisiana had their gm this week vs App St postponed and this game was moved up a week. Last ssn LA went to Coastal on a Thursday night and won 48-7 (564-236 yd edge, 30-14 FD edge). LA is off a scheduled bye week while Coastal hosted Ark St and put up 539 yds in a 52-23 win. Coastal is getting great play from QB McCall, who threw for 322 yds (69%, 4-1) vs Ark St and for the year he has 728 pass yds (67%, 9-1) and has ran for 139 yds. LA is 3-0 on the ssn, but their 2 SBC wins are by a combined 5 pts as they needed OT to get past GSt and a 53-yd GW FG to win vs GS. LA RB Mitchell has ran for 210 yds (8.8) this ssn, but overall LA has ran for 169 ypg (5.1) after they avg'd 257 yds (6.3) on the ground last ssn. 3★ Cincinnati (+) over BALTIMORE - After their only HG in a 5-week span a week ago against the Jags where RB Mixon had 181 ttl yds and 3 TD's, the Bengals head to BAL to take on a Ravens squad that rebounded nicely a week ago against WAS (QB Jackson 246 ttl yds, 3 TD's) following a rough MNF outing with the Chiefs. In their 2 meetings of a year ago the Ravens picked up 23-17 (-11) and 49-13 (-10) victories as part of their 12-game SU win streak to close out '19. While BAL has covered 11 of their L/14 contests coming in, they have gone just 1-6 ATS as a DIV HF. With the Bengals on a 4-0-1 ATS run, we'll go ahead and call for them to keep it close. **FORECAST: BALTIMORE by 4**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ NEW ENGLAND over Denver - The Patriots return home on short rest after a MNF matchup against KC where they were without the services of QB Newton due to a positive Covid test. The Broncos meanwhile picked up their 1st win of 2020 last Thur against the Jets with undrafted QB Rypien hitting 19-31-242-2-3 in his 1st career start. The Patriots have dominated this series dating back to 2011 with a 7-1 SU/ATS mark (only DEN win came in '15 AFC Championship). The most recent matchup was back in '17 where NE (-7) picked up a dominating 41-16 victory at "Mile High". While the Patriots went a perfect 6-0 SU/ATS prior to a bye from '12-'17 with a 24 pt avg MOV, the past 2 yrs has seen them lose outright in each as a favorite (21 pt avg defeat). Although DEN has covered 11 of their L/16 coming in overall, Belichick always dominates QB's making their 1st career start in Foxboro. **FORECAST: NEW ENGLAND by 14**

OTHER PLAYS

Tampa Bay at CHICAGO - Thursday - After a rough home effort against the Colts where the offense (15 FD's, 11 pts, 269 yds) struggled in QB Foles' 1st start of the ssn, the Bears are back inside of Soldier Field to take on a 3-1 Bucs squad that finished with 28-15 FD and 484-324 yd edges in a comeback win over the Chargers (TB trailed 24-7 late 2Q). In their last meeting (also in CHI), the Bears (-3) finished with 28-16 FD and 483-311 yd edges in their 48-10 victory (QB Trubisky 400+ ttl yds & 6 TD). In fact, CHI has won 10 of the L/15 in this series overall (9-6 ATS) dating back to 2000. While the Bucs have cashed 3 straight as an AF dating back to LY with a 14 pt avg cover, traveling for a Thur matchup is never easy. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

ATLANTA by 7 over Carolina - The Panthers have now picked up B2B victories following a 31-21 home win against the Cardinals where they finished with a 444-262 yd edge. ATL meanwhile returns home on short rest following a MNF trip to Lambeau against the Packers. The Falcons have owned this series over the past 4 ssn's with a 7-1 SU/ATS that includes 29-3 (+4) and 40-20 (-3) victories a year ago. Despite having a pair of rough home outings so far this year including another blown lead against the Bears, the Falcons have covered 8 of their L/12 overall and should get the job done here (CAR just 8-17 ATS vs DIV foes).

KANSAS CITY by 14 over Las Vegas - The Chiefs are back in Arrowhead on unexpected short notice after their matchup against the Patriots was postponed an extra day due to Covid. The Raiders meanwhile have now suffered B2B losses (383-336 yd edge in 7 pt defeat, -2 TO's) after their 2-0 start to the year. Similar to their other AFC West rivals, the Chiefs have owned the recent series with a 9-1 SU (7-3 ATS) mark that includes 28-10 (-7) and 40-9 (-11) victories a season ago. While KC does have a pair of road trips on deck including a Thur night visit to BUF, they have covered 8 of their L/9 overall coming in and should have no issue getting the job done in this one.

La Rams by 14 over WASHINGTON - Following their only home matchup in a 5-week span LW against the Giants where they allowed just 9 pts and 295 yds in the 8 pt victory (LA did have just 240 yds of offense), the Rams head to D.C. (third 10am PST start time in 4 wks) to take on a WAS squad that dropped a 14 pt contest a week ago to the Ravens (WAS backdoor cover w/2:05 left). The Rams and WAS last met in '17 with the hometown Rams (-2) falling 27-20 (WAS 21-14 FD and 385-332 yd edges). With the Rams covering 5 of their L/7 overall as an AF and WAS just 4-8 ATS in HG's, we're giving the visitor a 2 TD edge in this one.

HOUSTON by 3 over Jacksonville - The Texans remain in search for their 1st win of the 2020 campaign following an 8 pt home loss to the previously winless Vikings. The Jags meanwhile dropped an 8 pt contest of their own LW in CIN despite a solid effort from QB Minshew (351 pass yds, 2 TD). This series has seen a 2-game sweep in each of the past 9 seasons with the Texans going 14-4 SU overall (JAX 2-0 in '13 & '17) including a narrow 13-12 win LW in HOU (combined for just 544 ttl yds). While we'll go ahead and call for the Texans' series dominance to continue here, they have failed to cover 6 of their L/7 as a HF.

Buffalo by 7 over TENNESSEE - It's hard to believe that it's been 20 years since the "Music City Miracle"! The undefeated Titans are back in action after a week off due to positive Covid tests. The Bills have also been on the winning side of the scoreboard in each of their 1st 4 matchups following a 7 pt victory LW against the Raiders (QB Allen 288 pass yds, 3 pt TD's). BUF has actually picked up 3 consec victories in this series (2-1 ATS) including a 14-7 (+3) win LY in Nashville where they held the Titans to just 252 ttl yds. With TEN failing to cover 5 of their L/6 coming in and potentially having some key players out due to the virus, we'll give the visiting Bills (9-2-2 ATS run on the road) a TD lean.

Arizona by 3 over NY JETS - This marks the 2nd of 3 consec AG's for the Cardinals who head into empty MetLife Stadium following a 10 pt road loss to the Panthers where they were outgained 444-262. The Jets remain at home for a 2nd consec week after a Thur night defeat against the Broncos. Prior to their last meeting in '16 that saw the Cardinals (-7) pick up a 28-3 victory on MNF, the Jets had won 6 in a row in this series dating back to 1978 with a 10 pt avg MOV. With the Jets going 11-6-2 ATS as a HD and ARZ failing to cover 5 straight as a NDIV AF, we're cutting off our lean at just a FG for the visitor in this one.

PITTSBURGH by 10 over Philadelphia - The Eagles FINALLY got into the win column a week ago against the 49ers thanks in part to a +2 TO advantage (SF 25-18 FD and 417-267 yd edges). The Steelers meanwhile remain undefeated on the year and have extra rest after LW's game in Nashville was cancelled due to Covid. In the Steelers last matchup against PHI

back in '16, the Eagles (+3) dominated with a 34-3 victory (25-15 FD and 426-251 yd edges). With PIT going 7-2 ATS against NFC foes and the Eagles failing to cash 6 of their L/9 against the AFC, we'll call for the home team to get the win and cover.

SAN FRANCISCO by 4 over Miami - Rematch of SB XIX ('84 ssn) where Joe Montana and the 49ers picked up a 38-16 victory over rookie QB Dan Marino and the Dolphins. Despite solid FD (25-18) and yard edges (417-267) a week ago at home against the Eagles, a trio of TO's saw the 49ers drop a 5 pt matchup. The Dolphins meanwhile are sitting at 1-3 on the ssn after an 8 pt home loss to the Seahawks. In their most recent matchup back in '16, the Dolphins (-7) picked up a 31-24 home victory despite SF finishing with a 475-358 yd advantage. While the 49ers could see the return of a few missing starters in the near future including QB Garoppolo (CS here), they have failed to cover 19 of their L/26 when listed as home chalk (MIA is on a 11-5 ATS run!).

DALLAS by 7 over Ny Giants - Following a 8 pt road loss to the Rams where they finished with a 295-240 yd edge, the Giants head to DAL (return of former HC Jason Garrett, now OC of NY) to take on a Cowboys team that saw their defense allow 49 pts, 33 FD's and 508 yds in an 11 pt home loss to the Browns. The Cowboys are on a 6-0 SU/ATS run in this series with a 14 pt avg MOV during that span. In fact, they're 15-3 ATS vs DIV foes overall. The Giants however are a solid 12-3 ATS as an AD coming in and could get enough out of their offense in this one (DAL is DEAD LAST in ppg allowed at 36.5 ppg, 3rd worst in ypg allowed at 431 ypg) to stay within the line.

Minnesota at SEATTLE - SNF - Tough spot for the Vikings in this one as they head to the Pacific NW following their 1st win of the ssn LW on the road against the Texans (RB Cook 130 rush yds, 2 TD's). The Seahawks meanwhile are off to their first 4-0 start since '13 following another big day from QB Wilson (360 pass yds, 2 TD's) in an 8 pt win over MIA. The Vikings have now dropped 5 straight SU/ATS in this series dating back to '12 including a 37-30 (+3) defeat a year ago on MNF (SEA 24-17 FD and 444-354 yd edges). La Chargers at NEW ORLEANS - MNF - Following a 6 pt road win against the Lions where they scored 5 consec TD's after an early 14-0 deficit (NO 29-18 FD and 392-281 yd edges), the Saints return home to take on QB Brees' former team in the Chargers who nearly pulled the upset LW on the road against the Bucs (led 24-7 late 2Q). In their last meeting back in '16, the Saints (+4) picked up a 35-34 road win despite the Chargers finishing with a 346-275 yd edge (NO 4-1 SU/ATS series run). While the Saints are a solid 4-0 ATS prior to their bye week, the lack of a true home edge inside of the Superdome could allow rookie QB Herbert (290 pass yds, 3 TD's LW) to have enough success to keep this matchup close.
