## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ CINCINNATI over Arizona St** - Cincy is playing at home for the first time in nearly a month and they are off a 19-13 outright upset win at UCF where they forced 2 fumbles & stopped UCF on downs. Cincy did get RB Kiner back and he ran for 83 (4.9) last week and on the season leads with 496 (5.9). CIN QB Sorsby is hitting 66% with a 13-3 ratio. ASU is up to 5-1 on the season and just upset Utah at home, but now must travel cross country for a noon ET kickoff (9:00 am ASU time). Cincy did hold a good UCF offense to 92 yds under their ssn avg a week ago and face an ASU team that is just +14 ypg/+2 ppg in their L/4 gms and all 4 of their FBS wins are by 8 pts or less. Cincy's 2 losses are by a total of 4 pts so they could be 6-0 right now and are at home with the situation edge firmly on their side. Bearcats have been a money machine for us (3 key selection winners!) and we are going back to them for our top Newsletter play this week!

**FORECAST: CINCINNATI by 14**

**3★ CALIFORNIA over Ncst** - Ncst travels roughly 2800 miles to the west coast and this is their first trip to the state of California since 1960. Cal has lost 3 straight by just 8 combines points to FSU, Miami and Pitt. Last week the Bears traveled across country and held Pitt to a season low 277 yards (245 yds below their avg)! Cal is #3 in our pass D rankings (216 ypg, 55%) and is tied for #1 in the FBS w/13 int's. S Nohl Williams leads the country with 6 int's! Justin Wilcox is only 9-14-1 as a HF but this Cal team is 3 plays away from 6-0 and have the edge in all 3 phases while Ncst is traveling across country and are 0-7 ATS & -33 ypg. Cal came through for us as a 3★ on these pages two weeks ago as a big dog against Miami. Now we are going back to them as double-digit chalk for another Key Selection!

**FORECAST: CALIFORNIA by 21**

**3★ Wisconsin over NORTHWESTERN** - Wisky is out for legit revenge. Last year the Wildcats (+12) were ahead 24-3 at HT and held the Badgers to a season-low 86 yards on the ground en route to a 24-10 upset road win. Last time here ('22), the Badgers dominated the 1H leading 28-0 (+220 yd edge) in a 42-7 (-10) win. Wisconsin is off back-to-back wins by a combined 94-13, LW (+1) outgained Rutgers 549-271 in a 42-7 road win. NW (+11) outscored Maryland 20-3 in the 4Q to pull out the upset road win 37-10 but only finished w/283 yards (+4 TO's). The Badgers have the offensive edge (#27 vs #107) and the D edge (#15 vs #39). Wisky is holding their foes to 81 YPG below their season avg and are 25-14 ATS as a AF L/10 yrs so we will go with the Badgers by over 2 td's.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Alabama over TENNESSEE** - LTH the Vols ended their 15 game series losing streak and won 52-49. Last year UT was +9 and led Bama 20-7 at half but lost 34-20. Bama was off a loss last week and hosted South Carolina. The Tide jumped out to a 14-0 lead but trailed 19-14 3Q. Jalen Milroe threw for a td and ran for a td in the 4Q and the Tide won 27-25 (-22). The Vols offense has been underwhelming in their last 3 games, putting up just 20.6 ppg and 330 ypg. They haven't scored a first half point in either of their last two games and were fortunate to come away with the win over Florida in OT last week. Vols D is stout, holding foes 122 ypg below their avg but just lost Keenan Pili (#1 tk/r) to injury and this is by far the best offense that UT has seen. Nico lamaleava isn't a finished product and their WR's and OLine have struggled recently. Vols were fortunate vs Florida while Bama did beat Georgia and SCarolina so the Tide should roll here.

**FORECAST: Alabama by 10**

**2★ ILLINOIS over Michigan** - The Illini is 2-8 SU but are 7-3 ATS in their last ten matchups. Last meeting was in the Big House ('22), Illinois (+17) held the 17-16 lead with 3:14 left but went 3 & out and gave up a GW FG with :09 left. Mich is coming off a bye but in their last matchup they were at Washington. Wolverines (+1) were outgained 429-287 and lost 27-17. Illinois (-22) was looking ahead last week and blew a 27-3 3Q lead vs Purdue then stopped na OT 2-point conv to win 50-49. Illinois QB Altmeyer has been solid with a 14-1 ratio while Michigan's QB combine for a 6-8 ratio. Entering this week Illinois HC Bielema is 14-5 as a B10 dog including 8 outright upsets so we will back the home dog with a sold out crowd here!

## OTHER GAMES

### WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 16th

**SAM HOUSTON by 3 over Wku** - WKU won last year's meeting 28-23. Both teams beat UTEP in their last game. SH won two weeks ago 41-21 with a 517-323 yard edge. WKU beat UTEP 44-17 (-19) last week. SH is 5-1 and have won their last four games. The Bearcats are 2-0 in conference play. WKU enters 4-2 and both losses were to Power-4 teams (Bama & BC). Toppers QB Caden Veitkamp is hitting 70% and has an 11-5 ratio. SH QB Hunter Watson is hitting 59% with a 7-5 ratio but is also their leading rusher with 370 (4.4). SH is averaging 282 rush ypg in their last 4 but WKU is only allowing 112 (3.1) rush in their last 4. SH has the edge on defense, holding foes 44 ypg below their average. A lot to like on both sides so we are setting this at the line.

**Fiu by 10 over UTEP** - FIU is out for revenge for last year's 27-14 (-3) loss to UTEP. FIU nearly pulled the upset last week at Liberty. The Panthers led 10-3 2Q but lost in OT 31-24 (+17). The Panthers are 2-4 and have lost 7 straight CUSA road games. UTEP is still looking for their first win under HC Scotty Walden (0-6 SU/1-5 ATS). The Miners D is giving up 443 ypg including 236 (5.2) rush ypg and are allowing 56 ypg more than their foes average. FIU is only averaging 104 rush ypg (3.4). Keyone "Lights Out" Jenkins is hitting 63% with a 9-5 ratio. The Panthers D is allowing 408 ypg but actually holds foes 51 ypg below their average. FIU has been a much more impressive team and should get their first road win in conference since '22.

### Thursday OCTOBER 17th

**VIRGINIA TECH by 17 over Boston College** - It's a Thursday Night game in Blacksburg. The teams are fresh off a bye. VT is just 3-3 and won their last game 31-7 at Stanford who was playing without their starting QB. BC is 4-2 SU but are on an 0-3 ATS run and lost 24-14 (+1) at Virginia prior to the bye. QB Thomas Castellanos is not being used for his dual threat ability. Last year he rushed for over 1,100 yards but only has 103 (1.9) this year while throwing for 983 (67%, 12-4). VT QB Drones has a 7-3 ratio and has also been used far less as a runner (163, 2.7). VT has the edge on all three phases including huge edges on offense (#22 vs #83) and ST's (#38 vs #116). VT's last 10 wins have all come by at least 17 points and we always like to lean with the Hokies on a Thursday night with Enter Sandman.

**MARSHALL by 17 over Georgia St** - The home team has won both prior meetings as SBC foes. MU is off a loss to GA Southern where they led 23-3 into the 4Q but two costly fumbles allowed GStm to charge back and win 24-23. In that game MU went with both QB Earle (9-17 for 97 yds, 45 rush) and Braxton (9-12 for 92 yds, 2 td, 36 rush). MU is rushing for 202 ypg (5.4) and face a GSt rush D allowing 232 ypg (5.0) in SBC action. MU's strong DL has recorded 9 sacks in the last 2 games and face a GSt rush attack putting up just 99 ypg (3.2) the L/4 games. GSt's defense is allowing foes to gain 51 ypg above their season average (#116 FBS). Meanwhile MU has the #41 pass D and have allowed 137 rush ypg (3.7) in conf play. We feel like MU is the superior team and are 2-0 ATS off a SU loss this season, plus are at home against one of the weaker SBC teams.

### Friday OCTOBER 18th

**DUKE by 1 over Florida St** - FSU is 22-0 SU all-time vs Duke and on an 8-0-1 ATS series run but this is actually the first time Duke has been favored in this series. Last year both teams were ranked and FSU was -14. Duke actually led 10-0 and 17-7. FSU KR td, trailed 20-17 H. QB Leonard was inj'd in the 3Q and FSU won 38-20. FSU is just 1-5 and a bowl is unlikely with games against Miami, Notre Dame and Florida ahead. The 'Noles have yet to have 300 yards in a game (avg 274 ypg) and are -128 ypg. Both teams are fresh off a bye. Duke started 5-0 before their 24-14 loss to Georgia Tech

two weeks ago. FSU's Brock Glenn did throw 2 td passes vs Clemson 2 wks ago. Hard to go with a team that hasn't touched 300 yards yet but both teams look even and we will lean with the dog.

**Oregon by 26 over PURDUE** - Oregon is 2-1 vs Purdue but have not met since '08. The Ducks are 6-0 and made a statement in their first marquee B10 game knocking off Ohio St in thrilling fashion 32-31. Oregon trailed 31-29 with 6:00 left but drove down the field to kick a GW fg with 1:47, stopped OSU on downs to end the game. Purdue (+22') was without their starting QB but took Illinois into OT last week. The Boilermakers were down 27-3 at half but came back to take the lead 43-40 with :46 left and then allowed a GT FG as time expired. Purdue went failed their 2 point conv in OT to fall 50-49, backup QB Browne was solid going 18-26-297-3-0. Oregon HC Lanning is 8-3 ATS as an AF while Purdue Walters is 0-6 ATS at home in conference play. The Ducks are coming off an emotional win so we will put this right at the line.

**BYU by 17 over Oklahoma St** - In their first meeting as B12 foes LY the Cougars led 24-6 at HT but then needed a FG to force OT and lost 40-34 in 2OT. Okla St is off a bye but have dropped their first 3 B12 games in '24, and are -190 ypg/-16 ppg in B12 play. BYU enters this game 6-0 SU/ATS in '24 and we picked up a 4★ LP winner on BYU last week with a 41-19 win over Ariz where BYU were just +9 yds but +3 TO's. BYU's run game has picked up the L/2 games (149 ypg) and Okla St's run D is allowing 313 ypg (6.2) in B12 play and their D is allowing foes to gain 104 ypg above their season avg (#127 FBS). BYU is only off #120 rush ypg (3.7) and Okla St RB Gordon only has 362 (3.6). Okla St QB Bowman has a 13-8 ratio and BYU has the #1 pass D, allowing just 51% with a 4-10 ratio. With BYU at home in front of an electric home crowd and Okla St reeling, we like the Cougars to win by over 2 td's.

**NEVADA by 1 over Fresno St** - Fresno has won 5 of the L/7 meetings SU since 2017 including 3 straight, but have covered just 1 of the L/5 meetings. Nevada won last week against Oregon St despite getting outgained by 140 yds, but were +4 TO's. Nev also ran for 353 yards as QB Lewis had 151 (16.8) and RB Red had 137 yds (6.0) and 4 rush td's! Fresno is 3-3 on the season under interim HC Skipper but have dropped their last 2 games. QB Keene has just an 8-8 ratio on the season and their offense is getting held to 88 ypg less than their foes allow (#123 FBS). Nev's pass D did just record 4 int's last week. Nevada has been impressive this season, losing vs SMU by just 5 pts and have close losses to SJSt and GA Southern. QB Lewis is hitting 67% and also 513 rush (5.8) and Fresno is -90 ypg on the road. We like the 'Pack to get the home win here.

### SATURDAY OCTOBER 19th

**IOWA ST by 21 over Ucf** - First meeting. ISU enters this game 6-0 for the first time since 1938! The Cyclones are 5-0 ATS in games vs FBS foes in '24 and last week at WVU (-3) they won 28-16. UCF is off a 3rd straight loss, as they hosted Cincy and lost 19-13. ISU is allowing just 285 ypg and are holding foes to 91 ypg under their season average (#19 FBS) and their pass D ranks #5 as they have allowed 52% with a 5-10 ratio. UCF has allowed 14 sacks the L/3 games and face a talented DL. UCF has also lost a few players and did switch to QB Jacurri Brown last week. UCF's offensive strength is their rush attack led by RJ Harvey (694, 6.4) but ISU is giving up just 115 (4.0) the L/4 games. UCF has failed to cover 3 straight and this game is at night in Iowa St, where the crowd will be electric. Backed by a strong defense and a solid offense led by QB Becht (67%, 10-3 ratio) and a great run game (211, 5.0 the L/4 games) we like the Cyclones here by 3 td's!

**Wake Forest by 5 over UCONN** - The home team is 0-2 SU/ATS. These two last met in the 2007 Meineke Car Care Bowl won by WF 24-10. The Deacons are just 2-4 but did win their only road game at NC State two weeks ago. UConn is 4-2 and on a 3 game winning streak. UConn is 5-2 ATS vs the ACC under Mora including a home win over Boston College in '22 and they only lost at Duke 26-21 (+16) earlier this year. The Hokies are +111 ypg while WF is -80 ypg though WF has played a much tougher sked (#43 vs #125). The Demon Deacons do have two close losses to Virginia (led by 13 4Q) and Louisiana and their other losses came to top 25 teams Ole Miss and Clemson. Tough to go against UConn who is 11-5 ATS at home under Mora but the Huskies are actually favored and WF is much better than their record indicates.

**ARMY by 15 over East Carolina** - Last met in '04 as CUSA opponents, East Carolina has won the previous 7 meetings. Army is 6-0 for the first time since 1996 and are a perfect 6-0 ATS as well! Last week, the Black Knights (-27) outgained UAB 515-303 and had the +10 FD edge in a 44-10 win. East Carolina is coming off a bye and has struggled losing 3 of their previous 4. Army QG Daily has been stellar rushing for 6.9 YPC and has 14 td's along with a 6-0 ratio. The Pirates are 9-10 SU/8-11 ATS vs Military Academy tms, they held Navy to 276 yards LY and now have a bye to help prep for the option. Army's D is holding foes to 107 yards below their ssn average but have only faced the #131 schedule so we will put this one right at the line and see where it goes.

**James Madison by 3 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN** - Only prior meeting as FBS foes came last season where JMU (-6) only outgained GStm by 16 yds but were +3 on TO's and won 40-13. JMU is off a game last Thur where they 29-7 HT in a 39-7 win (+240 yds). GA Southern is off a 24-23 comeback win vs Marshall where they trailed 23-3 into the 4Q but forced 2 fumbles they turned into TD's and scored three 4Q td's. JMU QB Barnett has a 15-1 ratio and GStm does have the #104 pass D. GStm did lose QB French last week (63%, 7-2 ratio) but backup QB Dexter Williams came in and hit 71% and had a pass td + rush td. GStm also has the schedule edge (#74 vs #122) and the Eagles only 2 losses are to Boise St and Ole Miss. JMU lost their last road game at ULM and at UNC they allowed 616 yds. While we think JMU is the better team & they will get the win, the Eagles are getting over a td and at home we see them keeping it close.

**Miami, FI by 10 over LOUISVILLE** - Last year UL was #9 and won 38-31 (PK). 'Canes are 6-0, #6 in the AP and fresh off a bye. UM won their first 4 games by 42 ppg but trailed by DD's in both of their games prior to the bye, beating VT 38-34 (-17) and Cal 39-38 (-10). UL is 4-2 but have failed to cover 3 straight. We cashed a 3★ going against Louisville as part of our excellent 5-1 LPS record last week in their 24-20 (-7) win over Virginia. The Cardinals were outgained 449-408 and trailed 20-17 until a td with 1:55 left. The 'Canes have put up the most yards all 6 of their foes have allowed on the season. Cam Ward has a 20-5 ratio and the 'Canes avg 400 pass ypg while UL's pass D is #98 (65%, 5-2) UL is holding foes 49 ypg below their average but they've given up 481 and 449 in their last 2 games. UL QB Tyler Shough has a 14-3 ratio but UM is #9 in pass D efficiency (56%, 5-10). A lot to like here for Miami who is clearly the better team!

**Ohio by 1 over MIAMI, OH** - 100th meeting of the "Battle of the Bricks" rivalry. The winning team has also covered 8 straight meetings and there have been 4 outright upsets in the past 5 meetings. Ohio is tied atop the MAC standings early on in conf play and are 4-2 this season. They are rushing for 205 ypg (5.2) led by RB's Tyus and Hunt plus QB Navarro has B2B 100 yd rush games. Ohio's defense is holding MAC foes to 235 ypg but have faced just Akron and CMich. Miami got their first MAC win last week at EMich 38-14 where QB Gabbert threw for 222 and 4 td's but Ohio's pass D has allowed just a 6-4 ratio. Ohio allows just 110 rush (3.5) and Miami is rushing for only 99 (3.7). We like the 'Cats to go to Oxford and get the outright rivalry win.

**TEMPLE by 7 over Tulsa** - Tulsa has won the previous 3 mtgs. LTH ('22) the Hurricane (-13) had a 454-280 yd edge including 299-84 edge on the ground and a 4Q 84 yd rush TD helped seal a 27-16 win. LY Temple (+3) got outgained 533-313 and lost 48-26 on the road. Both teams are coming off byes. Tulsa is avg'ing 346 ypg and 17 ppg while giving up 468 ypg and 39 ppg in FBS play. Temple is avg'ing 294 ypg and 19 ppg while giving up 402 ypg and 36 ppg this ssn. Temple has faced the #39 schedule while Tulsa has faced the #110. The Owls are getting held to 95 yd's below their foes ssn avg (#128) and this is the 1st time that Temple is a conf fav s/20. The fav is 6-0 SU and 4-2 ATS. Temple has had a few impressive games and are at home so we will take the Owls by a td.

**BUFFALO by 6 over Western Michigan** - WMich is 8-2 SU but only 3-6-1 ATS in this series. WMich has won last 3 meetings. Both teams are 2-0 in MAC play. WMich won 45-42 two weeks ago at Ball St and last week won 34-24 (-9) vs Akron but were outgained 501-387 and +4 TO's. Buffalo's two MAC wins have come over NIU and Toledo, two of the preseason MAC favorites. The Bulls never trailed last week against Toledo and are at home again. Buffalo is 104 ypg against our #94 sked while WMich is -74 ypg against our #87 sked. Both teams have been fortunate in their MAC wins so we will go with the home team who is a small underdog.

**FLORIDA by 10 over Kentucky** - Florida dominated this series from 1987-2020 when they won 33 of 34 meetings but KY has won the last 3 and are on a 6-0-1 ATS series run. Last year FL was +1 on the road. The Gators were outtrashed 329-69 and lost 33-14. Gators played their best game at Tennessee last week but blew scoring opportunities and lost 23-17 (+14) in OT. QB Graham Mertz is OFY so it will be DJ Lagway the rest of the season. KY is the latest victim of the Vandy train after last week's 20-13 (-12) loss last week. KY's D has held all 6 foes to their season low yards and hold foes 176 ypg below their avg (#1 in FBS) but their offense is putting up 13 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. KY's offense avg just 21 ppg and 322 ypg while UF avg 28 ppg and 403 ypg. Gators have the edge on offense, ST's and the home edge and we can't see them losing to KY for a 4th straight year.

**Texas St by 7 over OLD DOMINION** - First meeting as SBC foes. TXSt is 2-0 in SBC play after a 41-19 win over Ark St where the Bobcats led just 17-9 HT but gained 323 yds in the 2H and outscored Ark St 24-0 2H in a 41-17 win. ODU picked up their 2nd win of the season last week at GA State, where ODU won 21-14 & we picked up a 3★ LP winner on the Monarchs! ODU is just 2-4 SU on the season but have covered 3 times as an underdog this season incl nearly beating SCar in the opener. ODU has the big schedule edge (#29 vs #111) and 5 of their 6 games this season have been within 8 points or less. TXSt's offense is gaining 101 ypg more than their foes allow (#9 FBS!) and QB McCloud is hitting 71% (19-5 ratio) but ODU was 2-0 ATS as a home dog vs SBC foes a season ago & pulled the outright upset in both. While we won't call for the upset, ODU has kept 16 of their L/19 gms within single digits and we see more of the same here.

**NAVY by 17 over Charlotte** - Second Meeting, teams are separated by 425 miles. Last year the game was tied at half with 12 possessions and 12 punts, Navy (-3) shutout the 49ers in the second half and scored twice to win 14-0. Both teams are coming off byes and Navy is 5-0 for the first time since 2017 while Charlotte is winners of 3 of their last four. In their last game, Charlotte (+9) put up their most yards since '21 and outgained East Carolina 517-343 in a 55-24 win. Navy (-10) put up 463 yards and beat Air Force on the road. Navy QB Horvath has been the leader of their offense rushing for 8.7 ypc and 10 td's along with a 7-1 ratio. Both teams are a combined for 9-2 to the over this year. Charlotte HC Poggi is 7-2 ATS as an AD and has had a bye to prepare for the options so we will put this game to finish right at the line.

**† Notre Dame by 7 over Georgia Tech** - ND won the last meeting in '21 55-0 (-17). Injuries are mounting up for ND as they've now lost their top CB, two DE's and 3 OL. Despite the losses, ND has won their last 4 games including LW over Stanford 49-7 (-22) and the Irish had a 477-200 yd edge. GT is 5-2 and are +59 ypg vs FBS foes. QB Haynes King has an 8-1 ratio and is the Jackets #2 rusher with 343 (5.4). Last week GT's RB Jamal Haynes scored on a 68 yd td run with :11 left to beat NC Carolina 41-34. Both tms ply'd L'ville with GT losing by 12 but were +84 ypg while ND won by 7 but were -115 ypg. ND is on a 14-2 ATS run vs ACC foes. Brent Key is 7-2 ATS vs ranked teams and the Jackets are getting double-digits against a team that has lost multiple key players so take the points.

**Louisiana by 7 over COASTAL CAROLINA** - The home team is 0-3 SU/ATS as SBC foes, but last met in 2020 where Coastal (+7) got the GW field goal with 4 sec left in a 30-27 upset win. LA is off to a 5-1 season with their lone loss to Tulane in a game where they were +66 yds. Coastal had a couple extra days rest as they played last Thur at JMU and lost 39-7 (-240 yds). LA is led by QB Woodridge who is hitting 69% with a 12-4 ratio and the Cajuns are rushing for 187 (5.4), plus their OL has all'd just 5 sks on 177 pass att. Coastal is allowing 431 ypg over their L/4 gms and on the season are all'g foes to gain 25 ypg above their avg (#99 FBS). Coastal also has the #80 pass D. LA holds foes to 38 ypg under their season avg (#44 FBS) and have allowed just 307 ypg. We have been more impressed with LA this season & like the Cajuns to win here by a td.

**EASTERN MICHIGAN by 1 over Central Michigan** - CMich has won 8 of the L/11 meetings SU vs EMich. The Eagles sit at 4-2 but did lose at home to Miami last week 38-14 but did win their MAC opener vs Kent 52-33 (+64 yds, +4 TO's). CMich is 3-3 on the season and nearly came back from down 24 last week vs Ohio to get the win, but fell 27-25 (-132 yds). CMich did suffer a big loss as QB Labas is OFY and Tyler Jefferson takes over as the starter. These teams rate nearly equal on offense, defense and ST's plus each have played a weak schedule (#128 EM, #130 CM). EM is just 5-11 ATS as a MAC HF since '16 and despite the QB loss, we think this game is close.

**CLEMSON by 24 over Virginia** - Clemson has won the last 5 meetings by 27 ppg. Tigers have won 5 straight (4-1 ATS) since their loss to Georgia. Last week Clemson led Wake Forest 28-14 with a 293-195 yd edge at half then had a 273-38 yd edge in the 2H and won 49-14 (-21). We cashed a 3★ LPS on Virginia last week as 7 point dogs vs Louisville. UVA nearly pulled the outright upset but allowed a td with 1:55 left and lost 24-20. Anthony Colandrea has a 9-4 ratio but faces a stiff test against a Clemson D that just held WF 198 yds below their season avg. Cade Klubnik has a 17-2 ratio and UVA is only #84 in our pass D rankings (61%, 8-4). If it wasn't for Clemson setting for 7 fg's two weeks ago vs FSU they would be on a 5-0 ATS run and we see a similar result the week against Virginia.

**Kansas St by 3 over WEST VIRGINIA** - As Big 12 foes KSt is 6-5 SU/7-4 ATS vs WVU and have won and covered the L/2 games. Last met here in '22 where KSt (-8) won 48-31. KSt is off to a 5-1 start and escaped Colorado with a 31-28 win where RB Giddens ran for 182 (7.3). WVU hosted Iowa St last week and trailed 14-10 HT but fell behind 28-10 2H in a 12 pt loss. WVU does have a good ground attack with RB's White (398, 5.9) and Donaldson (378, 4.7) plus QB Greene has 382 rush (5.9). KSt however does stop the run well (72, 2.5) but are allowing 292 pass ypg (66%) the

L/4 gms. WVU allows just 130 rush ypg (3.6) but will face Giddens (786, 7.3) and QB Johnson is the #2 rusher (306, 6.0). KSt is on their 2nd tough road trip in a row and Morgantown at night is a tough place to play. The line is right around a fg and that is where we see this game ending.

**MEMPHIS by 6 over North Texas** - Memphis leads the series 18-4. Last time here ('22) the Mean Green (+12') had the +141 yards edge but fell to the Tigers 44-34. Teams met for the first time as conference foes last year. Memphis (-7) was up 31-10 at half but gave up three unanswered 4Q td's pulled out the win with a 36yd TD with :12 to go, 45-42. Both teams have been impressive at 5-1 records. Last week, North Texas (-5') was down 37-27 with 8 mins to go but scored two td's then intercepted FAU to seal a 41-37 win. Memphis (-9) held USF to just 258 yards in a 21-3 win. North Texas has the offensive edge (#21 vs #70) but Memphis has the defensive edge (#47 vs #124). Memphis is just 3-7 ATS as conference home favorite since '20 including 3 outright upsets and North Texas has been rolling so we expect them to stay within the line in Memphis.

**TEXAS TECH by 10 over Baylor** - Since this game went away from a neutral site back in 2019 the home team is just 1-4 ATS in this matchup. TT is off a bye week and are in the mix for the B12 title game with a 5-1 record incl 3-0 in conf play. Baylor is also off a bye but have dropped 4 of their L/5 games and are 0-3 in Big 12 play. TT's offense is putting up 461 ypg/39 ppg and is led by QB Morton (63%, 14-2 ratio) and RB Brooks (679, 5.5, 7 td) and here face a Baylor run D that is allowing 175 ypg (3.9) the L/4 games and in B12 play Baylor is allowing 239 pass ypg. TT's defense is allowing just 120 rush ypg (3.8) the L/4 games and are holding foes to 32 ypg under their season average. TT is 5-3-1 ATS as a B12 HF under HC McGuire and are on a roll while Baylor is having their struggles in B12 play.

**BOWLING GREEN by 14 over Kent St** - Last season's 49-19 win by BG snapped a 5 game losing streak to Kent St. BG is just 2-4 on the season & seem to play to the level of their competition, playing Penn St & Tex A&M within a td, but losing to ODU and only beating Akron by 7 pts. BG is led by RB Stewart (334, 5.6) and TE Fannin (697, 13.9) but could be without QB Bazalak and they would be turning to 3rd string QB Lucian Anderson, who is more of a runner. Kent St has yet to win a game and are allowing foes to gain 188 ypg above their season avg (#134 FBS!) and their offense is putting up 114 ypg under what their foes allow (#130 FBS!). While we still think BG gets the win, Kent St showed life LW with Ulatowski at QB we think Kent stays within the line.

**South Carolina by 4 over OKLAHOMA** - First meeting. OK is off a 34-3 (+17) beat down vs rival Texas and the Sooners are 9-0 SU/7-2 ATS in the game following the Red River Showdown. OK averages just 288 ypg as QB's Jackson Arnold and Michael Hawkins have both been ineffective. SC's three losses have come to LSU by 2, Ole Miss by 24 and Bama by 2. Last week they actually led in Tuscaloosa 19-14 4Q and missed a late 2 pt cony that would have tied the game. SC is holding foes to 300 ypg and 122 ypg below their avg. OK is allowing 338 ypg and holding foes 85 ypg below their avg. They've both played top 10 schedule strengths but SC is +63 ypg while OK is -50. SC is clearly better on offense so we expect the Gamecocks to win a low scoring game.

**Toledo by 3 over NORTHERN ILLINOIS** - Toledo has won 3 of the L/4 meetings vs NIU and the 'Over' has hit in 4 of the L/5 gms (avg of 64 pts). Toledo lost at Buffalo last week to drop to 4-2 and did lose QB Gleason to an injury, but backup John Alan Richter was 16-23 for 227 and 2 td's so even if Gleason can't go, they have a solid option at QB. NIU is also having QB injury issues as Ethan Hampton left last week's game and backup Josh Holst was 10-14 for 89 yds, but RB Williams did step up with 102 (3.5), however they did not have RB Antonio Brown either last week. These are two banged up teams, but Toledo seems in better shape and we'll side with them by a fg.

**USF by 17 over Uab** - Second meeting as AAC foes and first trip to Tampa since 2003 for UAB. Last year UAB (+3) put up 608 yards of offense in route to a 56-35 win at home. UAB dropped to a 1-5 record last week, their worst start since 2012. The Blazers (-27') were without starting QB Zeno and their D gave up 515 yards in a 44-10 loss at Army. USF is coming off their 3rd straight loss. The Bulls (+9) were without their starting QB, outgained 231-69 under 14-3 at half and were shutout in the 2nd Half. USF is 5-10 ATS as a HF s/18 but UAB is 3-6 ATS as an AD the last 4 years. Both teams have ? marks at QB this week and have been struggling. The Bulls are 6-1 ATS in the 2nd half of B2B home games since '19 we will go with the Bulls to get back on track.

**RUTGERS by 14 over UCLA** - First meeting. This will be the first time UCLA plays in the EST zone since a game at Cincinnati in 2019. Last week, Rutgers (-1') hosted Wisconsin and were outgained 549-271 in a 42-7 loss. UCLA have dropped five straight including last week vs Minnesota. The Bruins did hold the Gophers to 234 yd's but were -3 TO's and let up a TD with :27 left. The Scarlet Knights are 10-4 as a home favorite since '20. The Knights RB Monangai has been great as he is averaging 5.5 YPC with 7 td's. Rutgers is on a 8-3 run as a single digit favorite. UCLA desperately needs to get to the bye week next week facing the #1 schedule and are traveling nearly 2,500 miles for this game, so we will go with Rutgers by 2 td's.

**Usc by 10 over MARYLAND** - First meeting. This is the Trojans' longest trip of the year 2,650 miles. Both have dropped two straight games. Last week, USC (+3) traded blows with Penn St, the Trojans scored a TD to take a 7 point lead with 5:56 left but allowed a TD next possession then missed a FG in OT to fall 33-30. Maryland (-11) held Northwestern to 283 total yards but the Terps turned the ball over 4 times which resulted in 13 NW points and were upset 37-10. USC and Maryland are offense is averaging right around 100 yards above what their foes are allowing this year but the Trojans have the edge (#11 vs #67). USC has faced the #4 foe rank (MD #54) and all three of their losses have been by single digits so they will be motivated to get a win here.

**UTAH ST by 6 over New Mexico** - USU has won 7 straight games vs NMex and have covered 6 of those 7 mts. Last season there was over 1,000 total yds in a 44-41 Aggies win. USU has yet to win a game vs an FBS foe this season as they are allowing 520 ypg/49 ppg vs FBS foe and overall are allowing foes to gain 121 ypg above their season avg (#131 FBS) as they are missing several key DL's. NMex has won their last 2 games but also struggle on defense, allowing 498 ypg/43 ppg and are allowing foes to gain 148 ypg above their season avg (#132 FBS). NMex is putting up 487 ypg the L/4 gms led by QB Dampier (1488 pass, 368 rush). USU is putting up 546 ypg in MW play and have averaged 289 ypg in their L/4 1H's! USU QB Petras since coming back from inj vs Temple has thrown for 1,126 yds (8-4 ratio) in the L/3 gms. This should be a high-scoring game but we will side with the home dog here to get the win.

**ARKANSAS over Lsu** - Great situation here for Arkansas who is fresh off a bye while LSU is off a massive win over Ole Miss. The Hogs are 4-1-1 ATS in this series and the last four meetings have all been decided by 3 points each. Ark is 4-2 and +163 ypg. They had the yardage edge in both losses but were -5 TO's in those. The Hogs have already pulled a home upset over Tennessee two weeks ago which won us a 3★ LPS and Sam Pittman is now 8-1 ATS vs ranked teams and is 20-9-1 ATS as an underdog with 9 outright upsets! We called for LSU to pull the upset over Ole Miss on these pages and they did exactly that, winning in OT 29-26. The Tigers trailed 17-0 but pulled out a fortunate comeback at South Carolina in their only previous true road game this year. Arkansas has a slight edge on defense and a HUGE ST's edge (#45 vs #114) which could be the difference and we will go with the Hogs outright for our Underdog POW! **FORECAST: ARKANSAS by 10**

**UTAH by 7 over Tcu** - Former MW foes have not met s/10 here where Utah won 47-7! Utah has dropped 2 straight games and are going to be without QB Rising for the rest of the season, so it will be Isaac Wilson (56%, 6-7 ratio) getting the starts from here on out. TCU is off a bye and two weeks ago vs Houston fell at home 30-19. TCU does come in with a strong pass attack led by QB Hoover (69%, 16-6 ratio) but Utah does have the #2 pass defense (49%, 8-7 ratio) allowing just 172 ypg. TCU's run defense has allowed 225 rush ypg (5.2) the L/4 games and Utah is led by RB Bernard (67%, 6.6). With Utah not having to deal with the Cam Rising saga and QB Wilson already having experience we feel like there is value on the Utes & at home we'll back them by a td.

**Colorado St by 10 over AIR FORCE** - The home team has failed to cover the last 7 meetings in this series. CSU did pick up a 4★ winner on these pages for us as well as a 3★ late phone winner with their 31-24 win again SJSt last week! Air Force has dropped 5 straight games and last week led NMex 28-17 HT but allowed the comeback and lost 52-37. CSU did lose star WR Horton for the season, but are starting to move the ball better on offense (447 ypg L/2 gms) and QB Fowler-Nicolosi has topped 250 passing the L/2 gms. CSU also has 3 straight 100-yd gms from RB Morrow. AF's offense is getting held 127 ypg less than their foes allow (#132 FBS!) and their defense has all'd 434 ypg the L/4 gms incl 247 rush ypg (5.9) and 71% completions. Despite the loss of their star WR, we feel the Rams are the better team & win here by 2 scores.

**SAN JOSE ST by 6 over Wyoming** - Wyoming has won just 1 of the 6 meetings vs SJSt as MW foes (2-4 ATS). SJSt is 4-2 on the season and have overachieved a bit as they are throwing for 332 ypg (61%) and WR Nash has 62 rec for 806 yds! However SJSt does have a battle at QB currently as Emmett Brown (59%, 16-4 ratio) and Walker Eget (71%, 0-1 ratio) are both getting reps. Wyoming fell to 1-5 on the season after a 27-24 loss vs San Diego St last week. Wyoming has faced the tougher schedule (#90 vs #121) have SJSt only has 1 win over an FBS foe more than 10 pts and that was vs Kennesaw St. Wyoming's defense has been better the L/2 gms all'g just 320 and 356 yds and the offense has topped 350 yds each of the L/2 gms. While we see SJSt winning, this line is too high in our opinion and like the Cowboys to cover the DD point spread.

**ARIZONA by 3 over Colorado** - Ariz has won 5 of the L/7 meetings SU. Last season Colorado (+9) got the GW FG on the final play of the game to win 34-31. Ariz has covered just 1 game this season (1-5 ATS) and have dropped 3 of the L/4 games. Last week vs BYU they were only -9 yds but -3 TO's and lost 41-19 on the road. Colorado came back from 21-7 last week and had the lead 4Q vs KSt in a 31-28 loss. Ariz QB Fiffita is hitting just 59% on the season with an 8-9 ratio and WR McMillian (742, 17.7) will have star CB Travis Hunter on him and no other Ariz WR has stepped up yet. Colorado gets back Hunter and WR Horn and will test Ariz's pass defense as will QB Sanders, who is hitting 73% (17-4 ratio). Colorado has covered 4 straight incl pulling the outright upset at UCF last month. We'll call for a close game here & a Colo upset wouldn't shock us.

**SMU by 20 over STANFORD** - Two first year ACC programs meet for the first time since 1936. SMU's only loss is to unbeaten BYU and they have covered 3 straight in wins over TCU, FSU and Louisville. Stanford has lost 3 straight, all by at least 24 points and are 0-3 ATS in those. Last week the Cardinal were +22 and got back QB Ashton Daniels but were no match for Notre Dame in a 47-7 loss. Stanford put up a ssn low 200 yards and allowed a ssn high 477 yards in the loss. SMU is fresh off a bye and is +94 ypg while Stanford is -64 ypg. QB Daniels has a 5-6 ratio while Kevin Jennings has sparked SMU's offense with a 6-1 ratio and Miami transfer RB Brashard Smith leads with 558 rush (6.8). After winning at Louisville, going to Stanford will be light work for SMU so we will call for the Mustangs to win by nearly 3 td's.

**VANDERBILT by 17 over Ball St** - Vandy has become quite a story this year after beating Bama, KY and VTech, plus a near upset win at Missouri but the loss at Georgia St is a real head scratcher. Clearly the 'Dores get up to play as a big underdog but they are laying 26 points here. Ball St is 2-4, coming off a 37-35 (-3) win over Kent St. The Cardinals do have blow out losses at Miami and Central Mich but Vandy has already proven they can overlook weaker opponents and they have Texas on deck. QB Diego Pavia has a 10-1 ratio and leads Vandy with 388 rush but was beat up by a physical KY defense last week and could be rested once they get a lead. Vandy is 1-5 as a HF under Lea and Vandy is in a clear flat spot so we will take the points. Ball St QB Semonza has a 12-7 ratio and Ball St avg's 27 ppg. Ball St's games have gone Over the Total in 6 straight so Over 58' in this game could be in the mix for our 4.5★ Totals GOM!

**KANSAS by 13 over Houston** - Last met in '22 where KU went to HOU and despite being -8 yds, were +2 TO's and won 48-30. KU is just 1-5 without a win vs an FBS team, but they have had the lead in the 2H of each of their losses. HOU is off a bye week as well and are now going with QB Chriss as the starter & in their last game at TCU was 15-18 for 141 and also ran for 97 (8.8). HOU's offense is gaining 58 ypg under what their foes allow (#116 FBS) and KU is holding foes to 29 ypg under their season avg. KU does have a strong run game led by RB's Neal (584, 5.8) and Hishaw (310, 6.5) and they avg 214 rush ypg (5.7) and HOU is allowing 152 rush (4.6) in B12 play. KU does have the #57 pass D and they have a strong pair of CB's. We think KU is better than their 1-5 record. HOU is holding foes to 126 ypg under their season avg (#6 FBS) and have hit 6 straight 'Unders' and this game could be in the mix for our Oct Totals GOM!

**Georgia by 3 over TEXAS** - Huge SEC showdown. Georgia looks to atone for their poor first half vs Bama and a loss here would all but eliminate the Dawgs from the SEC Title contention. Texas is 6-0 and ranked #1. The Longhorns are coming off a 34-3 (-17) win over rival Oklahoma. Quinn Ewers returned and threw for 199 yards. The Longhorns are 5-1 ATS this season and +266 ypg but have only faced our #60 sked. UGA is 5-1 SU but on a 0-5 ATS run. However the Dawgs are underdogs for the first time since '21's opener vs Clemson. UGA has played Bama and Clemson while Texas' D has yet to face a team with a top 60 ranked offense. Kirby Smart is 7-4 ATS as an underdog including 3-1 ATS vs #1 ranked teams. These Dawgs still bite so take the points.

**TULANE by 31 over Rice** - Rice leads the series 20-16-1 and this is their first trip to New Orleans since '12. Teams met every year from '05-'13 part of CUSA and last year was the 1st year as AAC

Rice came off their bye week and beat UTSA. The Owls (+3') put a up a season high 347 through the air in and kicked a GW FG with :04 left. Tulane has the huge edge on offense (#17 vs #105) and on defense (#28 vs #83). Tulane 3-0 ATS at home this season so we are going with them to continue their dominance in this conference matchup.

**Texas A&M by 21 over MISSISSIPPI ST** - Last year A&M dominated in this game 51-10 (-17'). Aggies have won 5 straight and are +95 ypg. Miss St has lost five straight and are -85 ypg. QB Michael Van Buren has already faced two of the top D's in the country on the road in Texas & Georgia and Miss St did cover both. The Bulldogs were about to be down 41-10 last week when UGA fumbled in the EZ and Mizz St scored 3 td's to only lose by 10. The Bulldogs already have home losses to Florida by 17 and Toledo by 24. A&M is fresh off a bye and in their only true road game they beat that same Florida team by 13 with a 488-301 yd edge. Aggies have a huge edge on D here (#17 vs #97). A&M is only laying 2 td's which seems cheap considering how bad Miss St has lost their home games.

**UTSA by 6 over Fau** - FAU leads the series 3-1. Last time in San Antonio ('19), the Owls had a season high 31 FD en route to a 40-26 win. The Owls are 2-4 SU and 2-5-1 ATS in road conference openers since 2018. The Roadrunners (-2') won the first matchup as AAC foes last year as they had the 437-162 yards edge and won 36-10. Last week, UTSA (-3') took the 27-23 lead with 2:06 left in the game but let up a GW 18 yd TD with :04 left. FAU (+5') took a 357-198 yards edge and 27-17 lead into HT and let up B2B TD drives late in the 4th to fall 41-37. FAU Tom Herman 10-4 ATS as an AD but UTSA Traylor is 21-14 ATS in conference play. UTSA is holding their foes to 95 yds (2.8 ypc) and are coming off a B2B road games. The Roadrunners have won 18 SU (12-6 ATS) conference home games so we will go with them to keep their streak alive!

**MISSOURI by 7 over Auburn** - Aub is 3-0 SU vs Mizzou in SEC meetings. Mizzou didn't overlook their opponent last week, beating UMass 45-3 (-27) on the road. Aub is 2-4 and looking for their first SEC win after losses to Ark, OK and UGA. Auburn did outgain both Ark and Oklahoma and only trailed Georgia 14-10 3Q. Their offense averages just 16 ppg in the conference games but 417 ypg while their D allows 21 ppg on the season and holds foes 63 ypg below their avg. The big issue has been -11 TO's. Mizzou is +5 TO's and +163 ypg though Auburn has played a much tougher sked (#53 vs #109). Mizzou's close win over Vandy doesn't look so bad and they did have a 440-298 yd edge vs BC. We trust Brady Cook and company to take car of the ball and win by a touchdown.

**WASHINGTON ST by 17 over Hawaii** - 6th meeting. Last met in 2009 in Seattle and UH won 38-20. WSU is off to a 5-1 start with their lone loss to Boise St (-44 yds) and last week they won 25-17 at Fresno. UH hosted that same Boise team and were -171 yds and lost by 21 but it was just 13-7 into the 4Q. WSU is led by dual-threat QB Mateer who has a 13-6 ratio and also is the #1 rusher (499, 5.3). UH's run D has allowed 165 ypg (4.3) the L/4 games and last week allowed 233 (5.5) to Boise. UH's offense gets held to 70 ypg under what their foes allow (#119 FBS) and only run for 81 ypg (3.2). WSU has faced the tougher schedule (#78 vs #124). While we see WSU winning, they are favored by close to 3 td's and s/21 are 0-4 ATS when favored by 17 or more at home.

**Unlv by 3 over OREGON ST** - 6th meeting, but first meeting since 2009. OSU comes in with a 4-2 record, but are off a loss as they fell at Nev 42-37 despite being +140 yds but were done in by 4 int's by QB McCoy. UNLV sits at 5-1 and last Fri went to Utah St and were up 41-7 HT in a 50-34 win where QB Williams had 233 with a 3-0 ratio and RB's Thomas (139, 8.2) and James (105, 8.1) both topped 100 yds. OSU is rushing for 256 ypg (5.3) with RB's Hankerson and Griffin, but Griffin did miss the last game (inj). UNLV does have the #22 pass D despite allowing 321 ypg the L/4 gms, they are tied for the FBS lead with 13 int and are +12 TO's. OSU is getting over a td and are 17-2 ATS at home since '21 incl 5-0 ATS as a home dog. OSU has gone 'Over' in 4 straight while UNLV has hit 3 straight 'Overs' and this game could surely be in the mix for our Oct Totals GOM!

**Iowa by 10 over MICHIGAN ST** - The Hawkeyes hold a slight 25-22-2 edge in the series and have won the last 2. Iowa has won just 2 of the last 7 meetings in East Lansing. Last year the Spartans led 16-10 in the 3Q as they outgained (394-222) and out FD (20-15) but gave up a FG to tie the game then a PR TD, Iowa capped off the game with a FG to win 26-16. Last week, Iowa's RB Johnson topped 100 yards and 2 td's for the 5th time in six games while the Hawkeyes dominated Washington 40-16. MSU is coming off a bye but did drop 3 straight prior. Spartans are avg'ing just 330 ypg along with 3.5 ypc and 16 ppg in FBS play. The Hawkeyes are on a 18-5 ATS run as a conference away favorite and 14-7 as a single digit favorite and like the away team to get the win.

**Arkansas St by 10 over SOUTHERN MISS** - Since 2005 Ark St is just 1-4 SU vs SMiss but 4-1 ATS. In their meeting LY Ark St (+6') pulled the outright upset at home 44-37. Ark St comes into this game 3-3 (faced #51 schedule) with 2 losses to Mich and Iowa St. Their offense is getting held to 34 ypg under their foes season avg (#108) and their defense is allowing foes to gain 53 ypg above their avg (#115). However SMiss has yet to get win vs FBS team and are -126 ypg and -16 ppg. They do allow 221 rush ypg (5.4) and have the #118 pass D. Ark St is 1-1 in the SBC and still has bowl hopes, while this is looking like a lost season for SMiss and we'll side with Ark St by 2 scores.

**INDIANA by 10 over Nebraska** - Nebraska has won 2 of the 3 matchups in B10 play. Last met in '22 when the teams were tied 21-21 at half but Indiana (+5) was shutout in the 2H falling 35-21. It is a whole different story for both programs. Indiana is 6-0 for the first time for since 1967. Nebraska is 5-1 for the first time s/14. Both teams are fresh off a bye. The Hoosiers QB Rourke is hitting for 74 % with a 14-2 ratio and Neb QB Raiola has a 9-3. Indiana is a perfect 6-0 ATS and Nebraska is 4-1-1 on the year. The Hoosiers have the offensive edge (#9 vs #88) and ST edge (#9 vs #107) while the Cornhuskers have the #8 vs #54 defensive edge. Both teams have been excellent ATS this year but we will go with the Hoosiers at home as they have been a cash cow for us this year!
