COLLEGE SELECTIONS TEAM IN CAPS

4★ Nebraska over MINNESOTA - The Golden Gophers lead the series 34-25-2 but Minnesota has been inconsistant TY, alternating ATS wins and the losses since their opening wk push against Ohio St at home (+14, 45-31) and losing their top player (RB Ibrahim). They now face the potential of being w/o replacement Treyson Potts, who has been excellent (552, 4.9, 6), after he left the Purdue gm 2 wks ago and was taken to the hospital w/ an undisclosed inj. They are off a bye but it's uncertain when to expect Potts back and the Gophers face a feisty Nebraska DLine that allows just 134 (3.9) rush ypg. The Cornhuskers are 5-1-1 ATS TY and nearly came away w/ an upset win at home over Michigan LW (+3), losing 32-29. Now they are laying less than a fg and they've got a huge edge on D so we like the Cornhuskers to win by double-digits. **FORECAST: Nebraska by 13**

3★ Louisiana Tech over UTEP - LT is 8-0 SU and the home team is 0-5 ATS. UTEP won at SMiss last week 26-13 (-2). The Miners held a 392-254 yd edge and rushed for 265 (6.8) but the Golden Eagles were also ply'g with a w/o QB. LT is fresh off a bye after nearly upsetting NCSt on the road, only losing by a td as 18' pt dogs. UTEP is 5-1 but their wins came over teams that have comb'd for just 1 win over an FBS foe while LT is 3 plays away from being 5-0 with close losses to Miss St, SMU and NCSt. Louisiana Tech will contend for the CUSA West so they won't have any problem getting up for a big divisional game against a 5-1 UTEP squad and Holtz is 17-11 ATS as road favorites while FORECAST: LOUISIANA TECH by 14 Dimel is 8-13 ATS as a home dog

3★ Texas Tech over KANSAS - From '08-'18 TT was 10-0 SU/7-2-1 ATS vs KU but the Red Raiders have failed the cover the L/2 gms & TT (-5) lost outright 37-34 the LTH. TT is off a 52-31 loss against TCU at home (3★ LP Winner on TCU) & now travel for the 3rd time in 4 wks while KU is off a bye & in their last gm they fell to lowa St 59-7. KU is getting outgained by 200 ypg vs 4 FBS foes & their D is all'g 552 ypg/51 ppg vs those FBS foes. TT has avg'd 458 ypg on offense but are w/o starting QB Shough, but bkp Colombi threw for 344 last wk. The TT D has mostly been steady but did allow Tex to gain 639 yds & TCU ran for 394 yds. TT's pass D is giving up 245 ypg to B12 foes & KU did throw for 323 yds vs Duke. We have no problem going against a Kansas squad that is on a 3-11 ATS slide vs B12 foes & overall are just 2-12 ATS the L2 FORECAST: Texas Tech by 23 OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ OKLAHOMA over Tcu - Since 2016 OU has won 6 straight SU against TCU & are 5-1 ATS in that span. TCU is off a 52-31 win at TTech (3★ LP Winner on TCU!) while OU benched QB Rattler against Texas, and bkp QB C.Williams led the comeback win 55-48 (OU down 35-17 late 2Q). OU's offense showed life as they put 662 yds (339 rush, 323 pass) and they face a TCU D that has given up 502 ypg/34 ppg against FBS foes & TCU's run D has given up 279 ypg (5.9) the L/3 gms. TCU does have a potent run gm (249 ypg, 5.9 ypc L/4 gms) however OU holds tms to 88 rush ypg (3.3) but the OU pass D has all'd 708 pass yds the L/2 gms and QB Duggan is a capable passer. The L3Y off the Texas gm OU is 3-0 SU/ATS with 2 of those wins coming against TCU while TCU is just 2-4 ATS the L3Y as a DD dog vs B12 foes. FORECAST: OKLAHOMA by 17

2★ Colorado St over NEW MEXICO - Since 2010 CSU is 10-0 SU and 8-2 ATS in this series. In their last mtg in '19 CSU (-3') trailed 14-7 2Q but scored 21 straight pts & won the game 35-21. CSU is off a 32-14 win against SJSt (+182 yds, +3 TO's) while NMex dropped to 0-2 in MW play after a 31-7 loss at SDSt. The Lobos are avg'g just 207 yds on offense the L/4 gms & go up against a CSU D that is all'g just 295 ypg the L/4 gms. NMex's OL has given up 13 sks the L/4 gms & now face a CSU D that has 15 sks the L/4 gms. CSU avg's just 385 ypg on offense & RB Bailey is a ? here but they have topped 200 yds in 3 of the L/4 gms and they face a NMex run D that has all'd 306 ypg (5.2) the L/2 gms. NMex is just 4-9 ATS the L5Y in true MW home gms & we see the stout Rams D shutting down NMex & getting enough production from their offense to win by 2 td's.

Georgia Southern at SOUTH ALABAMA - GS has won all 7 mtgs vs SAla SU as SBC foes and they have covered 6 of those 7 mtgs. LY SAla led 17-10 in 4Q on the road but GS (-3') scored 2 td's in the 4Q to win 24-17. SAla is off a road game at TXSt where they blew a 14 pt lead 4Q and lost 33-31 in 4 OT. SAla is at home for the 3rd time in 4 gms while this is GS's 2nd road game in 5 days. The GS pass D has struggled this season (337 ypg all'd) and take on SAIa QB Bentley who is throwing for 223 ypg & has a talented set a WR's. However the GS run game has been strong at times (253 ypg, 5.4 ypc) but were held to just 82 yds (2.2) last wk but SAla has all'd 220 rush ypg (5.6) in their L/2 gms. GS is just 2-5 ATS in their L/7 gms on the road, but GS has owned this series & ran for over 300 yds both times when SAIa HC Wommack was the DC here in '16-'17.

Navý at MEMPHIS - Tied 3-3 all-time, the Tigers have won B2B mtgs, but Navy is 5-1 ATS vs. Mem. LW Mem allowed a 3-play drive on 3 comp for 75 yds and a TD that gave Tulsa the lead 14-13 late 1H, then a 63-yd TD pass that extended it 28-13 4Q. They then missed several tackles as Tulsa powered their way to a 44-yd TD run to all but ice the gm, w/ Memphis falling 35-29 (+3'). Cuse is 5-2 ATS vs Clem including an upset win in '17 and they covered LY as 47' pt dogs, only losing 47-21. QB Shrader did his best Eric Dungy impression last week in Cuse's 40-37 (+5') OT loss at WF. Shrader ran for 178 and threw for 160 and Cuse finished with 514-426 yd & 33-21 FD edges. Clem is missing their top 2 DT's, their top RB and starting RG then WR Ross and TE Galloway both left their last gm with injuries. They was able to sort out their offensive issues during their bye week but are still banged up missing multiple starters and their offense avg 25 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. Clem is holding foes 111 ypg below their avg but Cuse isn't far behind, holding foes 62 ypg below their avg. Clem is on an 0-6 ATS run while Cuse is healthier and on a 7-1 ATS run so we think they keep this within single-digits.

Marshall by 4 over NORTH TEXAS - Only 3rd mtg for these CUSA foes with NT winning most recent in '16 and 2-0 ATS. We picked up a 3★ winner on these pages with the Mean Green in their 48-35 (+19) loss at Mizzou. QB Aune got his first start of the ssn and threw for 305 and 4 td's. MU is 3-5 as an AF vs CUSA foes and 4 of those were outright losses. MU needed OT to win as 3 td chalk over ODU LW. The Herd are allowing 73 ypg more than their foes avg (#111) and are giving up 214 rush ypg (4.3). Marshall has a pretty big edge on offense but are playing their 7th straight wk while NT had a bye 2 weeks ago. Marshall is 3-5 as CUSA AF with 4 outright losses. NT has the edge on

D and we will take the fresher team to keep it closer than expected.

San Diego St by 13 over SAN JOSE ST - In their F/7 mtgs as MW foes SDSt went 7-0 SU/6-1 ATS against SJSt but that streak was broken LY when the Spartans (+10) came back from an early 10-0 hole to win 28-17 despite losing QB Starkel in the 1Q. Starkel is a ? here and the SJSt offense is hole to win 28-17 despite losing QB Starker in the TQ. Starker is a : there and the cook should getting held to 112 ypg under what their foes typically allow & they face a SDSt D that is all'g just 270 ypg/17 ppg & are holding tms to 70 ypg under their ssn avg. SJSt is 3-0 ATS in the L/3 gms as a HD but SDSt is 4-2 ATS the L3Y as an AF and with QB Starkel banged up for SJSt we see SDSt getting revenge from LY's loss & winning by nearly 2 td's.

OREGON by 10 over California - The Ducks are back in action following a much needed bye week (upset loss vs Stanford in OT prior, 414-354 yd edge) to take on a Bears squad that also spent LW healing up after a surprising home loss to Wash St where the Cougars had 21-14 FD and 332-273 yd edges in the 21-6 victory. Cal has dropped 10 the L/12 to the Ducks but did win LY in Berkeley as a 9 pt dog despite a 368-271 yd disadvantage. With the Bears an outstanding 12-1 ATS as an AD coming in and the Ducks failing to cover 5 of their L/6 as home chalk dating back to the end of '19, we're expecting the visitor to stay within the line in this one. NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 8 over Bowling Green - Huskies have on won L/5 reg ssn mtgs (4-1 ATS). Last met in '17, NIU won 48-17 as a 14 pt AF. BG has not won in DeKalb since 1998. Both teams were winless last year, this year both have wins over P5 teams but while BG is winless in MAC play (0-2), NIU is in sole possession of 1st place in the MAC West (2-0). LW BG was favored over an FBS foe the 1st time s/18. BG led Akron 13-0 2Q but allowed 35 straight & lost 35-20 as a 14 pt HF. BG QB McDonald had 3 int in f/5 gms but threw 3 vs Akron. LW NIU was a 12 pt AD at Toledo. In a game that had 7 lead changes, NIU scored last hitting a GW FG w/:23 to win 22-20. NIU is avg 225 rush & 4.4 ypc while BG is allowing 179 ypg rush & 3.9 ypc. Still NIU has not beat an FBS tm by more than 7 s/ 18 & BG is 3-0 ATS (1-2 SU) as AD & have opened as a DD dog.

NORTH CAROLINA by 7 over Miami, FI- Mack Brown is 2-0 SU/ATS against the 'Canes and LY they embarrassed Miami's D by putting up 554 rush yds in their 62-26 (-3) win. Miami is plenty rested, fresh off a bye and 2 wks ago ply'd on a Thursday. They were w/o QB King that night and trailed 19-7 3Q but bkp QB Van Dyke led a rally and drove them inside the UVA RZ late 4Q but HC Diaz went conservate and they missed the GW fg. King is now OFY but Van Dyke threw for 203 and they've also got talented frosh Jake Garcia. NC has to once again bounce back off a loss after getting upset by FSU 35-25. NC led 10-0 1Q but allowed 3 td drives of 8 plays or more and trailed by 18 before scoring a garbage time td. As we've mentioned before this ssn, NC is now 5-0 ATS off a SU loss and their avg win in those is by 32 ppg but this is a desperate 'Canes team and all 3 of NC's

losses come from within the ACC so we question how motivated they will be.

Pittsburgh by 3 over VIRGINIA TECH - Pitt has owned this series, winning 8 of the last 12 and are 13-2 ATS vs the Hokies. The Panthers come in fresh off a bye while VT is off an emotional 32-29 (Pk) home loss to Notre Dame. The Hokies led 29-21 late 4Q but allowed a td, 2 pt conv & a fg all within the last 3 minutes. QB Burmeister was banged up (Hand) but did return when bkp QB Blumrick was also banged up. QB Pickett has been one of the best QB's in the country and has a 19-1 ratio but he's only faced our #118, #55, #82 and #112 pass D's and VT comes in at #23 (60%, 7-7). The Panthers avg 131 ypg more than their foes allow while VT puts up 46 ypg less than their foes allow. Pitt already proved themselves on the road (won at Tenn) and they've got a huge offensive edge so we can't help but call for Pitt to win but are surprised they are laying 6 points so we've got VT keeping it closer. We did win our 5★ Totals GOY on the UNDER in Bud Foster's last home game 2 years ago so we will take a look at this total once again, but perhaps consider using the Over since Pitt has gone above the number in all 5 games this year.

INDIANA by 3 over Michigan St - The Spartans lead this rivalry 48-17-2 but Indiana is 2-0 ATS S/19 (B2B road gms), including LY's 24-0 shutout in East Lansing. The Hoosiers are 16-10 ATS S/18, 11-1 as HF under HC Allen, and an inj to QB Penix (939, 54%, 4/7) might benefit their offense in the short-term. Michigan St drew Rutgers on the road LW (-5) and scored 4 TDs on plays of 60+ yds, winning 31-13. The Hoosiers have played a much tougher schedule than Michigan St so far (#16 vs. #49) and have used their bye week to rehab, while the Spartans are playing a 7th straight wk and in B2B road gms. We think a rejuvenated Hoosiers squad gets back on track.

WISCONSIN by 7 over Army - First ever mtg. The Badgers have not played a service academy since '79 and Army is 3-0 ATS in their last 3 gms vs. Power 5 foes, including memorable tilts at Oklahoma (+30', lost 28-21 in OT) and in the Big House (+22, lost 24-21 in 2OT). Wisconsin brutalized Illinois on the road LW (-11), shutting them out 24-0, but were a staggering +398 in yds w/ a 30-9 FD edge. The Badgers held the Illini to just 93 yds of total offense and are now holding opponents 188 yds below their ssn avg (#2 in FBS). However, Wisconsin is 1-6 ATS as HF since the end of '19 and 7-13 L4Y. QB Mertz is still struggling and the Black Knights are allowing just 54 rush ypg (2.4) so were leaning Army.

BUFFALO by 10 over Ohio - Both new HC's took over after spring as Ohio HC Solich retired un-expectedly & UB HC Lepold left for Kansas in May. While they DNP LY due to Covid the HT is 9-1 SU & ATS but Ohio has won 2 straight (1-1 ATS). Last met in '19 when UB lost after missing an XP in OT to lose 21-20 as a 3 pt HD. LW Ohio (+5.5) led CM 27-20 4Q but allowed the final 10 to lose 30-27. We won our 4★ top Late Phone play LW going against UB (+6) but after trailing 31-10 at HT actually took a 34-31 lead but missed 2 fg's as Kent St after taking the 3Q off won 48-38. Both have great rush gms, UB avg 210 ypg & 5.3 ypc, Ohio avg 150 ypg & 5.5 ypc. Both have trouble stopping run Ohio allowing 242 ypg & 5.4 ypc & UB 177 ypg & 4.1 ypc. UB is 0-2 in MAC play & must win to keep their slim hopes of repeating as MAC East Champs & should win here.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 25 over Vanderbilt- Two first year cch's meet looking for their first SEC win. SC has won 12 straight mtgs with 6 straight covers and their L/3 wins have come by 24.7 ppg. We did win a 3★ LPS on the 'Cocks in their 41-7 (-13') win over Vandy LY. The Gamecocks were blownout early at Tennessee LW, trailing 35-0 2Q and lost 45-20 (+10'). Vandy was no match for Florida in a 42-0 (+39) loss in Gainesville. The 'Dores could have been more competitive but K Bulovas missed 3 fg's and they had a td catch overturned. SC is +91 ypg at home while Vandy is -148 ypg on the road. The 'Dores are 0-10 SU/3-7 ATS in SEC road games and this is their 2nd straight while SC is 5-1 as a HF including 2-0 under Beamer so we like SC to win by over 3 td's.

Tulsa by 13 over UŠF - The Bulls are 3-1 all-time vs. the Golden Hurricanes but Tulsa is 3-1 ATS including LY's trouncing on the road, 42-13 (-11). The 'Canes are on the road in B2B mtgs but are 12-1 ATS the L3Y as visitors. Tulsa is coming off a 35-29 win at home against Memphis (-3') w/o their sack leader (DE Wick) and lost leading tackler, S Ray, after he was carted off mid 2Q. USF is off a bye but were w/o their starting RB and slot receiver the last 2 gms and lost a starting WR to an ACL 3 wks ago. Tulsa is 4-0 ATS as AF the L2Y while the Bulls are just 2-5 ATS S/18 as conf HD and 4-8 ATS as HD the L6Y. We see this fairly close to the line but USF is w/o an FBS win S/19 and we think Tulsa wins by nearly 2 td's.

Nc State by 1 over BOSTON COLLEGE - These two have split the L/4 mtgs while BC has covered 4 straight in this series. Both tms are fresh off a bye. 2 wks ago NCSt was off their upset win over Clemson and nearly got upset themselves by Louisiana Tech, winning 34-27 (-18). We've won two 4★ Late Phone plays on BC this ssn including 2 wks ago when the Eagles (+15) held Clemson to 19 pts and fumbled away a chance to pull the outright upset in a 6 point loss. NCSt's D is all'g 295 ypg and holding foes 68 ypg below their avg while BC is allowing 318 ypg and 6 ypg more than their foes avg. NCSt also has the edge on offense with QB Devin Leary hitting 67% (13-2) while BC QB Grosel is only hitting 61% w/a 4-4 ratio. The Pack outgained Clemson by 172 yds while BC was outgained by 81. NCSt has been a little more impressive against a tougher schedule (#88 vs #126) so we like the 'Pack to win a close game.

MIAMI, OH by 16 over Akron- Both are 2-4 SU & ATS & 1-1 in MAC play. RedHawks have won 4 straight over the Zips (3-1 ATS) & LY led 31-0 & won 38-7 as a 14 pt AF. LW MU had a 385-257 yd edge over EM but settled for 4 FG's & lost 13-12 as a 2 pt AF. Miami was again without starting QB Gabbert as experienced backup QB Mayer hit 16-39-259-0-0. LW Akron without dynamic QB Irons, saw an banged up QB Nelson struggle (6-10-91-0-1) & trailed 13-0 in 2Q. They went to rFr QB Zach Gibson who led a 2H comeback hitting 14-15-177 with a 3-0 ratio, leading them to a 35-20 win over BG as a 14 pt AD. While Akron is 1-2 SU& ATS as an AD TY, they are a dropped late 4Q td in EZ (from QB Gibson) vs Ohio St from being 2-1 ATS. MU is the better team but UA won outright as a 14 pt dog last week & have opened as a 20 pt dog here & that is just too much.

CINCINNATI by 27 over Ucf - This matchup is tied 3-3, w/ the Bearcats having won 2 straight. The Bearcats won on the road LY (-4'), 36-33, outgaining the Golden Knights 482-359 and earning the FD edge 28-23. Cincinnati outmatched Temple at home LW (-29') w/ +307 yds, a 23-14 FD edge, and won 52-3 in a gm that they dominated in the 2H (outscored the Owls 35-0). UCF was at home vs. ECU (-10) w/o their starting RB or WR and a true Fr. QB for a 2nd straight wk and needed a TD w/ under :30 sec left to escape 20-16. They outgained ECU 359-336 but lost the FD edge 16-21. The Bearcats are 4-0 ATS TY vs. the FBS while UCF is 0-4. Fickell needs some style points and they won't have any problem getting up for UCF so we've got the Bearcats by nearly 4 td's.

VIRGINIA by 16 over Duke- UVA is 6-0 SU/ATS in this series, but they are laying double-digits and their largest line recently was -4'. In fact the Cavaliers lost outright the last 2 times they've been favored by a td or more. Duke led GT 27-24 late 4Q before giving up a td with :51 left. The Blue Devils finished with a 489-440 yd edge. UVA trailed Louisville 30-13 in the 4Q then got 75, 73 & 75 yd td drives & won 34-33 (+2'). UVA avg 525 ypg and are +98 ypg ply'g against the #33 toughest schedule while Duke avg 497 ypg and is +68 ypg but againstly only the #109 toughest schedule. QB Armstrong has topped 400 in 4 of 6 starts including 554 earlier TY against NCar. Duke has our #90 ranked pass D. The Blue Devils are 0-2 SU/ATS on the road TY while UVA is on a 9-2 ATS run at home so we like the Cavaliers.

Rutgers by 9 over NORTHWESTERN - Rutgers is 3-1 all-time against Northwestern but they have met just once in the last 30 years. Rutgers lost at home (+20') in '18, 18-15, their closest loss SU and an ATS win in a 1-11 campaign to a Wildcats team that eventually played in the Big 10 Championship. While their last two gms (both at home) were SU and ATS losses, the Scarlet Knights are still 4-2 ATS TY and 6-0 ATS on the road under HC Schiano. Rutgers hopes to get WR Melton back and most of their defensive issues last week came on explosive big plays which NW hasn't produced this year. Northwestern is just 1-4 ATS TY after traveling to Nebraksa where they were outclassed (-11'), losing the yard and FD edge (-364 yds, 17-28) as the Cornhuskers rolled 56-7. As of presstime the game is a pick'em but if Northwestern is the favorite they are 4-8-1 ATS as home favs the L4Y. We like Rutgers to bounce back here with a win.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Ball St- EM is 3-2 SU & 4-1 ATS vs Ball St but have lost 2 straight. LY EM (+9) led 21-0 but lost 38-31 being outgained 546-513. Both are off outright upsets as dogs. Ball St shocked WM 45-20 as a 12' pt AD. The big reason was WM which came in with just 2 TO's & 0 int's imploded with 4TO's (2 int) which the Cardinals turned into 28 pts as they were actually outgained by 1 yd. The Cardinals actually trailed 20-17 before scoring the final 28 including a FR td. EM won a defensive struggle over Miami 13-12 as they held Miami to 4 FG's. Because of the Cardinals "blowout" win, EM is once again the dog. LW we called for EM to get their 13th outright upset as a dog s/16 & they did & are now 28-7-1 ATS in the role, so look for #14 here.

COLORADO by 10 over Arizona - Two of the bottom-feeders in the P12 square off here as the Wildcats have now dropped 17 straight following LW's home matchup against the Bruins (outscored 20-3 in 2H). The Buffs meanwhile haven't fared much better in '21 after dropping their 4th consecutive contest against the Trojans prior to their bye week (avg just 9 ppg over their losing skid). While the Buffs have lost 7 of the L/9 including 4 straight here in Boulder (1-3 ATS), they did rally from down 13-0 a year ago in Tucson in the eventual 24-13 victory (-7'). With the Wildcats being held to 19 pts or fewer in 8 straight coming in and also failing to cover 12 of their L/16 inside of the P12, the Buffs get the small lean here prior to their 2-game road trip.

BOISE ST by 4 over Air Force - Boise is on a 4 gm SU/ATS win streak in series. LY these tms met at AF and Boise was w/o QB Bachmeier and got outgained 484-459 but benefitted from a KR TD

and won 49-30 (Won 5★ on Boise -14 LY!). AF is off a 24-14 win vs WY (3★ LP winner on UNDER 46') while Boise pulled the upset at BYU (-101 yds but +4 TO's). Boise all'd 415 rush (6.3) to AF LY and this san Boise's run D has been shaky at times (255, 5.3 vs UCF & 235, 5.6 vs Utah St) and now face an AF rush attack that is avg'g 376 yds (5.5) the L/4 gms. While Boise's run gm has struggled (85, 2.3) QB Bachmeier is avg'g 282 pass ypg (65%, 11-4) and AF's pass D has mainly been good (187 ypg, 51% all'd) execpt for the 448 yds all'd to USU. Boise's OL has also all'd 13 sks the L/4 gms & AF has 7 sks the L/2 gms. Boise has lost their L/2 gms this ssn outright as a HF and while we think Boise comes away with the SU win, AF comes into this gm 11-4-1 AT's as an away dog since '15.

Arizona St by 6 over UTAH - Following an emotional 16 pt win over the Trojans where QB Rising threw for 306 yds & 3 TD's, the Utes return to SLC for their 1st HG since the tragic death of DB Aaron Lowe. The Sun Devils meanwhile picked up an 18 pt win over the Cardinal last Friday with 430-369 yd and 3-1 TO edges. While the Utes have lost 13 of the L/16 in the series, 3 of those wins have come in the L/5. Despite an 11-5 ATS mark inside of the P12 for the Utes, we expect ASU to get the job done here as they've covered 5 of their L/6 conf matchups including a 42-23 win a few wks ago in Pasadena as a 3 pt dog.

WYOMING by 1 over Fresno St- Ås MW foes FSU holds a 4-1 SU/ATS record. Their last mtg came back in '18 where WY went up 3-0 early but were shutout the rest of the gm in a 27-3 loss at FSU. The Bulldog offense has played well this ssn (520 ypg/39 ppg) led by QB Haener (2230, 70%, 18-6) who had a week to rest following a 4 int gm at UH 2 wks ago. WY is off a 24-14 loss at AF (3★ LP winner on UNDER 46').WY's D is only all'g 171 pass ypg (57%) but this is by far the best pass attack they've seen. WY's offense isn't super explosive but they have a stout rush attack (167, 4.2) & in their last gm FSU all'd 232 rush yds (5.3). The Bulldogs do have a solid overall D that is only all'g 319 ypg and have collected 15 sks, but WY's OL has all'd 7 sks in 5 gms. WY has the home edge of playing in the altitude & while FSU did play in some high elevation gms LY they lost at Nev & at NMex. WY comes into this game 10-4 ATS as a HD since '16 so we will call for a small upset here.

WASHINGTON by 3 over Ucla - The Huskies are back at home at just 2-3 on the year after a 3 pt road loss to the Beavers in Corvallis. The Bruins meanwhile rebounded from a home loss to the Sun Devils with an 18 pt win over Arizona where they put up a ssn-high 329 rush yds. UW has won the past 2 meetings including the last meeting in '18 where they got their 1st victory in the Rose Bowl s'95. With the Huskies being a HD for just the 3rd time in the past 6 yrs and having some extra rest following a bye week, we're expecting them to get the outright upset here as the Bruins have failed to cover 6 of their L/8 as an AF.

Liberty by 38 over ULM - These tms met last season at Liberty & the Flames picked up a 40-7 blowout win (400-198) as blocked a punt for a TD, recovered a muffed punt for a TD and ret'd a punt for TD. Liberty is playing on the road for the 4th time in 6 wks while ULM is at home for the 2nd straight wk. Liberty is off a 41-13 win vs Mid Tenn while ULM hosted GSt and lost 55-21. ULM has all'd 515 ypg to FBS foes this ssn and face a Liberty offense led by dynamic QB Willis that is awg'g 444 ypg/35 ppg. LU has held tms to just 266 ypg & 14 ppg but have played just the #91 schedule however ULM's offense is awg'g just 238 ypg/16 ppg & are putting up 102 ypg less than what their foes allow on awg (#126 FBS) while their D is giving up 114 ypg above their foes ssn awg (#125 FBS). Liberty is 4-2 ATS under HC Freeze as an AF & we see the Flames torching ULM by over 5 td's.

BAYLOR by 1 over Byu - These teams have met twice before (1983-84) with the home squad winning both times. BYU got up 10-0 early on Boise St & were +101 yds but were -4 TO's (Boise 14 pts of TO's) and fell 26-17. Baylor is off a home win vs West Virginia where they got up 28-7 & won 45-20. Baylor's offense showed life last week as they put up 525 yds including 336 pass yards from QB Bohanon (4 td passes), but do face a BYU defense that has allowed just 338 ypg over their last 3 gms. BYU has a solid rush attack (166, 4.8) & Baylor did allow over 215 rush yds to both lowa St and Oklahoma. BYU did throw for 302 last week however they face the #13 ranked pass defense here. Baylor did collect 6 sks last week but faces a BYU OLine that has allowed just 6 sacks all ssn. While we think Baylor edges out BYU, the Cougars do come into this game 7-2 ATS under Sitake as an away underdog vs P5 foes.

Texas A&M by 16 over MISSOURI - Former Big 12 rivals that joined the SEC together meet for the first time since '14. The Aggies will try to avoid an emotional letdown after their huge home upset over Bama LW. QB Calzada threw for a career high 285 yds and 3 td's. We went against Mizzou in their 48-35 (-19) win over North Texas, picking up a 3 ★ winner as part of our 5-1 day on these pages! The Tigers are -97 ypg vs FBS foes and have been outgained by all 5 they've faced. A&M avg 155 (5.0) rush ypg and should have their best game yet against a Mizzou team that struggles with big physical OLine's, allowing 287 rush ypg (6.1) and has taken body blows, ply'g 7 straight weeks vs physical teams like KY, BC & Tenn. Mizzou is -62 ypg while A&M is +23 ypg but A&M has plyd' a much tougher sked (#9 vs #86). Mizzou is on an 0-9 ATS run and HC Fisher will have the Aggies refocused and full of confidence. Missouri has also gone Over the Total in all 5 games and A&M just put up 41 points on Bama so could the Over be in the mix for our Totals GOM?

The Hawkeyes have put up 31 yds less than their opponents allow on avg (#95 in FBS). The Boilermakers have had an extra week to heal and prepare for this gm and the visitor is 10-1 ATS, the dog is 5-1 ATS, and the home tm is 4-7 S. List this matchin. The Poilermakers haveled by holding the protection of the protect SU in this matchup. The Boilermakers should be healthier off their bye week and Iowa is in a letdown spot as DD chalk after being small favorites in B2B wins. Iowa's two stints as DD chalk resulted in a 10 pt home win over Colo St and a half point cover over Kent St. We will gladly take the points here.

TEXAS by 3 over Oklahoma St - From 2010-18 OSU won 7 of the 9 mtgs SU (5-3-1 ATS) but Texas has won the L/2 mtgs incl LY when the Longhorns won 41-34 on OT despite getting outgained 530-287 as Tex had 20 pts off 4 TO's, plus a KR TD. Tex is off a 55-48 loss to OU (led 35-17 late 2Q) while OSU is off a bye & enter this gm 5-0. OSU has had several offensive players miss time TY so their D has stepped up holding foes to 136 ypg under their ssn avg. Tex comes in with an offense that is putting up 102 ypg more than what their foes allow on avg & they are rushing for 291 ypg (6.3) the L/4 gms but OSU's run D is all'g just 90 ypg (2.7). OSU has found success with the run gm (200, 3.7 the L/3 gms) & Tex has all'd 198 ypg (5.3) rush the L/4 gms but are also all'g opposing QB's to hit 71% the L/4 gms. With OSU off a bye & Tex off an emotional loss we think the Cowboys can keep this gm close. OSU is also 4-1 ATS as an away dog since 2018.

Toledo by 7 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN UT has won 10 of L/11 vs CM but lost LTH 49-7 as a 10' pt AD. LY the Rockets won 24-23 finishing with just a 391-362 yd edge despite being an 11 pt HF. Both are 1-1 in MAC play tied with the rest of the MAC West behind 2-0 NIU. UT is in a little worse spot as they lost to NIU LW 22-20 as a 12' pt HF allowing a GW FG with :26 left, which means they will need NIU to lose an extra game for UT to win the division. While CM was able to score the final 10 for a come from behind 30-27 win over Ohio, but failed to cover as a 5' pt AF, their 4th straight ATS loss. UT is 3-0 ATS & 2-1 SU on the road TY coming up just short of upsetting then #8 Notre Dame in their only SU road loss. Look for the Rockets to keep their road magic alive.

Uab by 22 over SOUTHERN MISS - UAB is 7-2 SU/5-4 ATS but SMiss won the most recent mtg in '19 37-2 when UAB Dylan Hopkins was forced into his first career start when QB Johnston was inj'd. We won a 2★ on UAB last week on these pages in their 31-14 (-4) win over FAU. The Blazers led 14-0 1Q and never trailed. SMiss started w/o QB Jake Lange in their 26-13 (+2) home loss to UTEP. The Golden Eagles avg just 38 rush ypg in the L/4. UAB had 8 sacks LW vs FAU and should have a field day against SMiss' Oline that has allowed 28 sacks (16%). The Blazers are more battle tested (#27 vs #116 sked) and SMiss is 0-5 ATS vs FBS foes under new HC Will Hall so we will call for UAB to win by more than 3 td's.

Alabama by 14 over MISSISSIPPI ST - Bama is 13-0 SU vs MSU and has cov'd 5 of the last 6 including a 41-0 win last year, finishing w/a 499-200 edge. Miss St is fresh off a bye and 2 weeks ago did what Bama couldn't do...win in Kyle Field. MSU outgained the A&M 438-297 & won 26-22. Bama did hold a 522-379 in LW's shocking road loss at A&M and the Tide have covered their L/3 off a SU loss including in '19 against these same Bulldogs when Bama won 38-7 (-18'). Bama has the edge on offense while the defense's are nearly even. QB Rogers has a 14-2 ratio and has looked much better than A&M's QB who threw for 285 last week. Bama is 0-2 ATS on the road this year and we think MSU can keep this within 2 td's.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Kent St - LW we won a 2★ Power Sweep selection & a 4★ LP selection on Kent St over Buffalo. They led 31-10 at HT & despite forgetting to play in the 3Q! (outscored 28-3), they played up to their talent level in 4Q pulling away for a 48-38 win as a 6 pt HF. QB Dustin Crum threw for 407 yds with a 3-0 ratio becoming the first Kent St QB with 400+ pass yds since 2004. WM came into LW's game with just 2 TO's & QB Kaleb Eleby came in with 0 int, but with 2 int from Eleby & 4 TO's overall that led to 28 pts for Ball St, WM lost 45-20 despite having the FD & yardage edges. Kent St has the edge on Off (#20-#55) but WM has the edge on defense (#81-#119). Two weeks ago WM beat Buffalo on the road 24-17 as a 7 pt AF finishing with a 457-282 yd edge. LW Kent St beat UB by 10 at home finishing with a 633-549 yd edge. In a likely shoot out we will take the MAC East leading Flashes and the points.

Wku by 14 over OLD DOMINION - WKU is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS and last met in '19, winning 20-3. ODU nearly pulled an outright upset as 3 td dogs last week, losing 20-13 in OT at Marshall. We said the Monarchs had the edge on D and they held the Herd 91 yds below their avg. ODU once again has the edge on D but WKU has a HUGE edge on offense, avg 550 ypg and 231 ypg more than their foes allow on avg (#1 in FBS!). The 'Toppers have put up the most yards all 5 of their opponents have allowed and Bailey Zappe has a 21-3 ratio! WKU also allows 480 ypg and 103 ypg more than their foes avg. We hit a 3★ Totals play last week with the OVER in WKU's wild 52-46 (+3') loss vs UTSA. We call for WKU to win by 2 td's and with the 'Toppers games going OVER in all 5 we will certainly consider this for our Totals GOM!

GEORGIA by 28 over Kentucky - UGA has won 11 straight meetings. KY has covered 2 straight but UGA covered 7 straight previous to those. The Dawgs are 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS this year, winning by 34 ppg and we've been more than happy to use them including a 4★ winner on these pages last week (as well as a 4★ LPS) in their 34-10 (-15) win at Auburn. KY handled LSU last week 42-21 (-3) but only finished w/a 475-408 yd edge and got a fumble and 3 SOD's. UGA is +249 ypg and holding foes 206 ypg below their avg. KY is holding foes 106 ypg below their avg. QB Daniels is still a ? but Bennett has been more than adequate (8-2 ratio). KY hasn't topped 200 yds passing against an FBS foe since wk1 and UGA holds foes to just 67 rush yds and hasn't given up a 1st half td yet this year. We won't hesitate to go back to the Dawgs by 4 td's. We won our 4★ Top LP Totals Play 2 weeks ago with UGA going under against Ark (37-0) then won our Early Bird Totals Comp (Free Tuesdays on Button 9, call 1-347-677-1700) last week going with UGA under again. Could we go with Georgia's D for another Under as our Totals GOM?

Florida by 6 over LSU - FL is out for revenge after having their playoff hopes dashed LY as 23' pt chalk when a shoe throw gifted LSU a first down and the Tigers made a 57 yd GW fg. For the first time under Orgeron LSU has lost 2 straight after last week's 42-21 (+3) loss at KY. FL won 42-0 (-39) last week against Vandy but were fortunate to cover considering Vandy missed 3 fg's and had a td catch overturned. The Gators avg 151 ypg more than their foes allow and 276 rush ypg (6.7) and LSU just allowed 330 rush (7.3) against KY. Two of LSU's best players, WR Boutte and DE Gaye left LW's game and the Tigers were already decimated with injuries. The Gators will get their revenge and Orgeron's seat gets even hotter.

Mississippi by 3 over TENNESSEE - Ole Miss is 5-1 ATS in the series but they haven't met since 14. The Vols enter after B2B dominant performances, winning by 38 at Mizzou then LW led 35-0 2Q vs SCar (-10'). Tenn is rushing for 254 (5.3) and RB Evans has 482 (6.6) but did get banged up late. Ole Miss stopped Ark's late 2 pt conv to hold on 52-51 (-5'). The Rebels put up 611 yds but they also allowed 676. Battle of 2 of SEC's top QB's this year. Corral has a 12-0 ratio while Hooker has a 13-1 ratio. Neyland Stadium will be fired up after their 2 impressive wins and the fans will have extra ammunition with Lane Kiffin returning to Knoxville for the first time as a head coach. We aren't ready to call for the upset Ole Miss is 1-6 as an AF and the red hot Vols have won B2B SEC games by 33 ppg Troy by 12 over TEXAS ST - As SBC foes Troy is 6-0 SU and 5-1 ATS against TXSt & under HC Lindsey Troy has won both mtgs (20 pt win LY, 36 pt win in '19) & have covered both gms by 13 and 29 pts. TXSt is off a 33-31 4 OT win against SAla where they came back from 14 down in the 4Q to force OT. Troy led 24-3 against GS last wk but gave up 21 straight pts before kicking the GW FG to win 27-24. TXSt's offense is only avg'g 346 ypg this ssn & are getting held to 110 ypg under what foes allow on avg. TXSt faces a Troy D that are holding tms to 272 ypg & are only giving up 95 rush ypg (2.6). TXSt's OL has all'd 13 sks the L/4 gms and they face a Troy pass rush that has 24 sks in 5 gms vs FBS foes. Troy QB Powell missed last wk and his staus is ? as of presstime. Bkp QB Watson did throw for 270 yds last wk & TXSt has the #79 ranked pass D. TXSt is 5-1-1 ATS the L2Y as a home dog, but we can't ignore the series history & think Troy wins by nearly 2 td's.

lowa St by 2 over KANSAS ST - KSt won 10 straight vs ISU from '08-'17 SU but have lost 2 of the L/3 mtgs SU. Both teams come into this gm off a bye. KSt has dropped their L/2 gms after starting 3-0 but did get back QB Thompson in their last gm & he threw for 320 yds. KSt ran for 226 (5.4) the F/3 gms but in the L/2 gms ran for 81 ypg (3.1) and face an ISU D that is holding tms to 153 ypg under their ssn avg (#4 FBS) but they did allow KU to run for 175 (4.0) in their last gm. KSt's D is holding tms to 62 ypg under their ssn avg, but do face an ISU offense that has avg'd 512 ypg the L/3 gms but 2 gms were vs KU and UNLV. ISU has beaten lesser foes but lost to lowa & Baylor while KSt has wins vs Stanford & Nev plus only lost to OU by 6. KSt is 6-1 ATS as a HD under HC Klieman & with QB Thompson having an extra week to rest we think KSt keeps this gm close at home.

ARKANSAS by 6 over Auburn- Aub has won 5 straight mtgs but LY Ark nearly pulled the upset and was on the wrong end of a contraversial call that aided Aub's 39 yd fg drive. Ark is off B2B losses to UGA & a heartbreaker last week against Ole Miss. The Hogs finished with 676-611 yd & 39-22 FD edges and tied the game 4 times in the 2H but Pittman went for 2 after their final td and Ark failed, losing 52-52 (+5'). We won our 4★ top Power Sweep play (also 4★ LPS) going against Auburn in their 34-10 (+14') loss to UGA. QB Nix is just 5-8 as a starter away from home with a 13-12 ratio and while they did upset LSU on the road 2 wks ago, they did trail 13-0 early and needed Nix to make miraculous plays to rally. Ark has ply'd the toughest sked in the country (Aub only #70) and we don't think Pittman will let them have a letdown after 2 straight losses.

UTSA by 14 over Rice- UTSA has won 5 straight meetings and covered the L/2. The Roadrunners come in 6-0 after beating WKU last week 52-46 (+3"). QB Harris threw for a career high 349 yds and 6 td's. Rice is fresh off a bye and has won their L/2, but those came against FCS TX Southern and a beat up SMiss tm down to a w/o QB but their 3 prior losses all come vs tough opponents (Ark, UH & TX). The Owls have ply'd the tougher sked while UTSA hasn't beaten an FBS team by more than 14 points so that's where we will set the line.

Utah St by 7 over UNLV - USU has won the last 5 games against UNLV SU and have covered the L/2 gms but there last mtg came in 2018 (59-27 USU win at home). Both teams come into this game off a bye. UNLV is off to an 0-5 start while USU opened the ssn 3-0 SU/ATS but have dropped their L/2 gms SU/ATS (Boise St/BYU). UNLV's defense is giving up 454 ypg and their pass D (ranked #129) is all'g 303 ypg & USU's offense is avg'g 344 pass ypg in their L/4 gms. QB Bonner did get hurt 2 wks ago but had a week to rest & bkp Peasley is a quality QB. USU's D however is all'g 490 ypg/33 ppg the L/4 gms. & UNLV's offense did put up 433 yds/30 pts 2 wks ago at Fresno. This is USU's first game as a favorite against an FBS team since 2019 & UNLV has covered 3 of their L/4

gms as an underdog. We'll take the Aggies to win by a TD.

Stanford by 4 over WASHINGTON ST - It's been an eventful 2 wks for the Cardinal who picked up an outright upset over the #3 Ducks on "The Farm" along with falling short in Tempe against the Sun Devils (10 of 11 drives into ASU territory, just 10 ttl points!). The Cougars meanwhile picked up a 7 pt win over the Beavers with QB de Laura throwing for 399 yds & 3 TD's. After dropping 8 straight in this series from '08-'15, WSU has won the L/4 (SU & ATS) including LTH in '19 (scored final 24 pts in a 49-22 victory, -10'). With the Cougs still failing to cover 11 of their L/18 inside of the P12 and the Cardinal already knocking off USC and Oregon this season, we'll go ahead and give the visitor the lean in this one.

NEVADA by 20 over Hawaii - From '12-'18 Nev went 5-1 SU/ATS against UH but in the L/2 mtgs UH has pulled the outright upset on Nev. UH comes off a bye & in their last gm they were outgained by 157 yds but forced 6 TO's & won 27-24 vs Fresno. Nev is off a 55-28 win against NMSt. Nev is 4-1 this ssn and their offense, led by QB Strong (1595, 69%, 14-3) is avg'g 443 ypg incl throwing for 357 pass ypg & they face a UH pass D that is ranked #18 (4 int's last gm) but they have all'd 292 pass ypg this ssn incl 388 to Fresno. Since their opener (292 yds, 10 pts) UH has avg'd 447 ypg but Nev's D is holding tms to 375 ypg & they have 12 sks the L/2 gms, but their pass D has all'd 813 comb'd pass yds the L/2 gms. Since 2018 Nev HC Norvell is 3-0 ATS off a scheduled bye & UH is 2-4 ATS since 2019 as an AD against MW foes. QB Strong won't make the same mistakes against this UH pass D & we think he has a big game and the Wolf Pack win by nearly 3 td's at home.

The Dolphins had no answer for the Bucs offense LW in Tampa (outgained 558-301 in a 45-17 defeat). The Jags meanwhile had their own defensive issues with the Titans picking up a 37-19 victory. In their meeting a year ago, the Dolphins (+3) picked up a 31-13 road upset of JAX. With the Jags having failed to cover 7 of their L/10 prior to a bye week and 8 of their past 9 overall, we'll give a lean to the Dolphins here as they've covered 13 of their L/20 coming in. The Packers should feel right at home inside of Soldier Field as they've won 10 their L/11 in the "Windy City" including a 35-16 victory in LY's season finale (Rodgers 240 pass yds & 4 TD's). With GB covering 9 of their past 13 NFC North matchups overall, we have no issue backing them in this one.

WAS meanwhile gave up a couple of huge defensive mistakes (incl Hail Mary before HT) in an 11 pt home loss to the Saints where we picked up a 3.5★ Top Play LP and 3★ Newsletter Winner! KC has dominated the all-time series against WAS with a 9-1 overall mark that includes a 29-20 Arrowhead victory in '17 where they finished with a 29-15 FD & 429-331 yard edges. They are however on just a 1-11-1 ATS run coming in while also failing to cover 4 of their L/5 against the NFC. With WAS picking up covers in 6 of their past 9 as a NDIV HD, we're cutting off our lean at just a FG for the visitor. CAROLINA by 7 over Minnesota - The Vikings are back on the road following a 3-game homestand that included a 19-17 win a week ago against the Lions where they connected on a GW 54-yd FG as time expired (MIN 384-288 yd edge). The Panthers meanwhile have now dropped 2 straight since their 3-0 start as the Eagles overcame a 9 pt HT deficit in the eventual 21-18 victory. In the Panthers' trip to MIN a year ago, the Vikings (-3) needed a 10-yd TD pass with :46 remaining to pick up the narrow 28-27 victory (MIN 26-21 FD & 387-374 yd edges). While the Vikings were on a perfect 10-0 ATS prior to a bye, they have failed to cover in that position over the past 2 years including a 17 pt upset loss to ATL LY as a 4 pt favorite.
