KSt sits near the top of the B12 race and are off to a 6-1 start while their in-state rivals picked up their first win vs an FBS foe last week, beating HOU 42-14 (+132 yds, +4 TO's). KU has had issues against the run, allowing 178 ypg (4.9) in B12 play and just allowed 313 (7.0) to Ariz St in their last road game. KSt's rush attack, led by RB Giddens (843, 6.6), is putting up 223 ypg (6.2). KU does rush for 214 ypg (5.8) but face a KSt run D that is allowing just 83 ypg (2.7) and they have 20 sks this ssn. KSt is now 13-2 ATS in home games vs B12 foes since 2020, winning those games by an average of 23 points. KU is just 5-11 ATS as an away dog under HC Leipold and this season KSt is +150 ypg/+27 ppg at home. KSt delivered us our Sept 5★ GOM winner in Sept, could we go back to them this month? **FORECAST: KANSAS ST by 21**

3★ † Notre Dame over Navy - East Rutherford, NJ. 97th meeting. Notre Dame has won 11 of the last 12 meetings. This game is the third ranked matchup s/76, Notre Dame 2-0 SU/ATS including in '19 when ND beat #21 Navy 52-20 (-7). Last year these teams met in the ssn opener in Ireland, ND (-20) outgained Navy 444-169 in a 42-3 win. Since getting upset by Northern Illinois in week 2, the Irish have outscored their foes 41-10 including last week vs Georgia Tech in ATL. Notre Dame (-13) held GT to just 2.2 ypc in 31-13 win. Navy is 6-0 for the first time since 1979. LW the Middies (-16) only had 288 yards but were +5 TO's including two pick-6's in a 51-17 win over Charlotte. Notre Dame is +120 ypg against our #18 toughest sked while Navy is +46 ypg but has only faced our #127 toughest sked. Navy has been a great surprise for college football but the Irish are holding foes to 118 yds below their season average so we will go with them to keep rolling here. **FORECAST: Notre Dame by 21**

3★ INDIANA over Washington - Indiana is 7-0 for the second time in program history, 1967. The Hoosiers QB Rourke injured his thumb but backup Jackson went 7-8-91-2-0 last week. IU (-6) took at 28-7 lead at half and benefited with 28 points off 5 Nebraska turnovers in a 56-7 win. Washington is coming off a bye and we cashed a 4★ LPS going against the Huskies in their last matchup at Iowa. The Huskies (+2) actually outgained the Hawkeyes 393-328 but only down 20-10 at half went INT then three straight SOD in the 2H to lose 40-16. Both teams are solid going above what their foes are allowing, Indiana is at 131 ypg and Washington at 94. Rourke is out for this game but Jackson was a highly recruited player and has starting experience. The situation also favors Indiana with the game starting at Noon ET (9 AM PT). Hoosiers HC Cignetti is 19-4 ATS in conf play and 7-0 SU/ATS this year so we will take them to continue their great play at home. We've cashed 3 Key Selections on these pages with Indiana and are going back to the Hoosiers again! **FORECAST: INDIANA by 17**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Maryland over MINNESOTA - Maryland leads the series 4-3 though they haven't met since '21, when the Terrapins (+4) lost 34-16. Minnesota is coming off a bye and the two weeks prior they upset USC at home then followed that with a come from behind win at UCLA but were outgained 329-234. Maryland (+7) hosted USC and was down 28-14 in the 4Q but scored two td's along with a few defensive stops to win 29-28. Maryland has a huge edge on offense, avg 434 ypg and 96 ypg more than their foes allow while Minn avg just 319 ypg and are putting up 73 ypg less than their foes allow. Billy Edwards is #1 in the B10 with 2,113 yds, is hitting 70% and has a 13-4 ratio. WR Tai Felton is #1 in the B10 with 803 yds. We felt Minn was fortunate to beat UCLA and they did allow 293 pass yards in that game. We feel the Terps are the better team and will pull the upset!

FORECAST: Maryland by 4

2★ COLORADO ST over New Mexico - Since 2010 CSU is 12-0 SU/10-2 ATS vs NMex and more recently have won & covered the L/4 meetings. Since their bye week, CSU's offense has turned a corner, avg'g 433 ypg and what has taken off is the Rams rushing attack, as they are rushing for 198 (5.0) over the past 4 games led by RB Morrow (622, 6.5) who has 4 straight 100+ yd games. NMex comes into this game with a productive offense (513 ypg, 43 ppg L/4 gms) but their defense is struggling, allowing 499 ypg/43 ppg and are allowing foes to gain 133 ypg above their season average (#131 FBS). NMex's run D is allowing 240 ypg (6.0) and their pass D ranks (#128) as they are allowing 64% and a 16-2 ratio. CSU QB Fowler-Nicolosi has been better the L/3 weeks, as he has a 4-1 ratio and is hitting 65%. CSU did lose WR Horton but have WR's Goodie and Winfield who are stepping up. At home we like the Rams by 2 td's. **FORECAST: COLORADO ST by 14**

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 23rd

Liberty by 28 over KENNESAW ST - Liberty comes in off a rare double bye and thanks to their cancellation against App State they've played just one game in the last month. Flames are 6-0 on the season and +129 ypg but 1-5 ATS with the only cover coming against East Carolina when they trailed 17-0 but went ahead then scored late while running the clock out. Kennesaw St is 0-6 and are -177 ypg. KSU averages just 228 ypg and their QB's combine to hit just 48% for 126 pass ypg and a 2-9 ratio. Hard to trust Liberty as a big favorite as they are 0-9 ATS when -20 or more but they have a massive talent edge and KSU lost to Jax St by 39 at home a few weeks ago.

JACKSONVILLE ST by 31 over Middle Tennessee - Last year Jax St was +3 and won 45-30 but they are now -21. Gamecocks started 0-3 but during their 3 game winning streak they are +36 ppg, +250 ypg and +11 TO's. MT just played Kennesaw St last week and only won 14-5 with only 284 total yards. Jax St beat KSU 63-24 the week prior and had a 577-270 yard edge. QB Tyler Huff is hitting 66% with a 7-4 ratio and is their #1 rusher with 503 (6.6) and 6 TDs, plus Tre Stewart has 472 rush (5.5) and 10 td's. Jax St has been dominant in their last 3 and are at home while MT has 4 losses by more than 21 points so it only makes sense to lay 3 td's here.

Thursday OCTOBER 24th

PITTSBURGH by 7 over Syracuse - Pitt is 16-3 SU/13-6 ATS vs Cuse since '05. Pitt is out for revenge for last year's 28-13 (-3) loss in Yankee Stadium. Cuse used TE Dan Villari at QB. Pitt led 13-7 at half but down 14-13 Cuse got a pick-6 then a 2 play/34 yd td drive as Pitt lost 28-13. Both tms are fresh off a bye. Pitt is 6-0 but could easily be 3-3 with double-digit 4Q comebacks against Cincy and WVU and barely held on against Cal. Cuse is 5-1 and prior to their bye they won in OT at UNLV then beat NCSt 24-17 (-3). These two both have high powered offenses led by transfer QB's. Pitt averages 41 ypg, 481 ypg and avg 37 ypg more than their foes allow (#49 in FBS). Syracuse averages 34 ppg, 433 ypg and 77 ypg more than their foes allow (#18 in FBS). Pitt does have the edge on D, holding foes 22 ypg below their avg but Narduzzi is just 9-14 as an ACC home favorite so we are cutting our lean off at Pitt by 7.

Georgia Southern by 3 over OLD DOMINION - The road team has pulled the outright upset in both prior meetings as FBS foes. Both teams are off home conference upsets as ODU beat Texas St 24-14 while GS beat James Madison 28-14 and were +154 yds & the win could have worse as GS was -4 TO's. These teams have 1 common SBC foe so far and GS had the more impressive win as they were +113 yds & +15 fd's while ODU was +26 yds and -1 fd's. GS has the edge on offense (#79 vs #100) and an even bigger edge on ST's (#24 vs #93). GS QB Frech is hitting 64% with a 10-5 ratio and face an ODU pass D ranked #73. GS is also +99 ypg in SBC play while ODU is -21 ypg. We feel like GS is the better team & are getting points, so we'll go with GS by a fg.

Friday OCTOBER 25th

Louisville by 4 over BOSTON COLLEGE - Home team has won the last 6 meetings (5-1 ATS). BC is 4-6 SU but 6-4 ATS vs UL. Last year UL led 42-14 at half w/a 371-199 yd edge and won 56-28. Both tms enter 4-3 on the season. We've cashed LPS plays going against the Cardinals in their last two losses including last week in Louisville's 52-45 (+5) loss which was our 4★ top LPS play! BC was in a tough spot last week playing in Blacksburg on a Thursday Night. They trailed 28-0 at half but did score 3 td's to get within 7 then were SOD at midfield and VT added two td's. UL has been outgained by all 4 ACC foes (-59 ypg). BC is 3-0 SU at home under Bill O'Brien and are getting a td here. Castellanos is a dangerous QB and we think BC can keep it close.

USC by 14 over Rutgers - First meeting for the teams that are separated by 2,763 miles which is Rutgers' longest trip since '16. Both teams have dropped 3 straight games. USC is 3-4 but all four losses have been by one score games. LW the Trojans (-7) led 21-7 at half and 28-14 in the 4Q but after missing a FG allowed MD to score in 48 secs to fall 29-28. Rutgers (-4) let up their most passing yards in a game s/'16 (383) vs UCLA, they did pull within 2 late in the 3Q but allowed 3 straight scoring drives to lose 35-32. The Knights are dealing with injuries on both sides of the ball. USC HC Riley was just 8-17-1 ATS as a HF but is 2-0 ATS in that role this year. Rutgers HC Schiano is 34-22-2 an away dog. The Trojans have the edge in all three phases while also having faced the #6 toughest sked in the country. We will put this right at the line and see where it goes.

Boise St by 10 over UNLV - Boise St is 6-0 SU vs UNLV since 2011 and since '15 Boise is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS against UNLV. Last met in the MW title game last season with Boise (-2) was +229 yds in a 44-20 win here. UNLV is playing for a 5th straight week & are playing on a short week while Boise is off a bye. Boise's offense is avg'g 290 rush ypg (7.7) led by star RB Jeanty (1248, 9.9, 17 td) and the OL has only allowed 6 sks. UNLV does only allow 106 rush (3.4) but this is by far the toughest test yet & their pass D is giving up 341 ypg (64%) the L/4 games. Boise held this UNLV "go-go" offense to 81 rush yds (2.9) last season & this season are allowing just 106 rush ypg (3.1) and they have 28 sks. UNLV is +12 TO's on the season but Boise has just 3 TO's all season. We feel like the strength of Boise's run game & Dline will propel them to a win here.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 26th

TOLEDO by 3 over Bowling Green - 89th meeting of the "Battle of I-75" and while Toledo has won 6 of the L/8 SU, BG has covered 5 of the L/8. Toledo had to go with backup QB John Alan Richter last week and he was 15-28 but Toledo had just 285 yds & 13 pts. BG QB Bazelik played and the Falcons put up 444 yds in a 27-6 win vs Kent St. Toledo does have the edge on offense (#92 vs #109) and on ST's (#7 vs #48) but BG does hold foes to 34 ypg under their season average (#52 FBS) and BG is allowing just 268 ypg in MAC play, but that is vs Akron, NIU and Kent St. They do have a common foe in NIU and Toledo won by 7, but were -106 yds, while BG lost by 10 as their QB was hurt 2H. These teams look even to us & we'll call it at the line.

MIAMI, FL by 28 over Florida St - FSU has won the last 3 in this series but UM did cover last year as 14' point dogs, losing 27-20. LTH FSU embarrassed Miami 45-3 (-7) in Coral Gables. Roles are reversed now with Miami 7-0, +271 ypg and ranked #6 while FSU is 1-6 and -97 ypg. Miami has a MASSIVE edge on offense here, avg 577 ypg and they've put up the most yards all 7 of their foes have allowed. FSU avg just 273 ypg and they've yet to reach 300 yards in a single game this ssn. FSU only lost to Clemson by 16 but was -250 yards and Clemson settled for 7 fg attempts in that game. Miami also has a defensive edge here, holding foes 61 ypg below their avg. Miami's D is #14 in the FBS with 53 tfl's while FSU is #115 in the FBS, allowing 7 tfl's per game. Canes won't have mercy against their rival and Cam Ward will have another big game.

UCF by 6 over BYU - Last met in the 2020 Boca Raton Bowl where BYU won 49-23. BYU played last Fri at home vs Okla St where they needed a 35-yd td with 10 sec left 4Q to get the win & remain undefeated. UCF has now dropped 4 straight games but the last 2 games were by 6 pts or less. Last week at ISU they were nearly a 2 td dog but ran for 354 yds (9.1) and nearly pulled the upset (38-35 loss). BYU's run defense did struggle last week vs Okla St (269, 7.3) and UCF's offense is led by RB Harvey (890, 6.7), plus they made the switch to QB Jacurr Brown, who is more mobile and ran for 154 (11.8) last week. In conf play UCF is actually +11 ypg while BYU is -21 ypg. Off an emotional win, now heading cross country for a tough road matchup we feel like UCF is catching BYU in a good spot and can get the win.

VIRGINIA by 7 over North Carolina - UVA is 5-2 SU/6-1 ATS in this series. NC started the season 3-0 but they've lost 4 straight including two close losses and they played Pitt tough in a 10 pt loss. RB Omarion Hampton leads the ACC with 901 rush yds (5.8). He faces a UVA defense that allows just 133 rush ypg (3.9). UVA started the season 4-1 but have lost their last two as underdogs to Louisville and Clemson. They did lead Louisville late 4Q and only trailed 17-10 last week at Clemson but were underdogs in both and are now laying 5 points. UVA has played the tougher sked (#48 vs #74) but NC has a big ST's edge (#10 vs #97). NC is fresh off a bye and they have yet to mail in a game but Tony Eliott is now 13-6 ATS vs the ACC including 4-0 ATS this year so we have a small lean on the Cavaliers.

AKRON by 1 over Eastern Michigan - Akron has lost the last 4 meetings vs EM, including last year 30-27 (+3) in OT. Zips are 1-6 but have played our #56 schedule including losses to Ohio St, Rutgers and South Carolina. Akron is fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they had a 501-387 yard edge but lost to WMich 34-24 (+9). EMich is 5-2 but has only played against our #128 sked. Last week EMich trailed CMich 34-16 then scored the final 3 td's and won 38-34 (-3). The Eagles are 41-21-1 ATS on the road but only 26-38 SU. Akron QB Ben Finley threw for 395 yards two weeks ago. We think Akron is better than their record and has a good chance to get their first MAC win.

JAMES MADISON by 28 over Southern Miss - First meeting. SMiss is off to a 1-6 start and just let go of HC Will Hall, while JMU returns home and is angry off an upset loss at GSthrn where they lost by 14 pts despite being +4 TO's. SMiss struggles to stop anyone on defense, allowing 455 ypg overall and 247 rush ypg (5.7) the L/4 games. SMiss's defense is also allowing foes to gain 82 ypg above their season avg (#125 FBS) and they have the #119 pass D. JMU is led by QB Barnett, who has a 16-1 ratio and also is the #2 rusher (305, 4.2). JMU does have an explosive offense that is capable of putting up big numbers. Off a loss earlier this season they hosted Coastal (-9) and won 39-7 with a 421-181 yd edge. JMU is holding SBC foes to 281 ypg/19 ppg and we feel like off a loss and SMiss fresh off firing their HC this is a great situation for JMU.

Northern Illinois by 6 over BALL ST - Underdog has covered last 5 meetings and last three have resulted in outright upsets. NIU is 4-3 and off a 13-6 loss to Toledo where they had a 391-285 yd edge but were SOD 6 times in the loss. Ball St is 2-5 but last week they led Vandy early and only lost 24-14 as nearly 4 td underdogs. NIU has a huge edge on D here (#7 vs #133) but Ball St has the edge on ST's (#70 vs #113). Ball St's big issue has been their pass D which has allowed 311 ypg and a 23-2 ratio but NIU played with a backup QB last week and they only average 185 pass ypg. Series history says take the underdog and we agree as Ball St is getting 12 pts.

VIRGINIA TECH by 11 Georgia Tech - Visitor is 13-2 ATS in this series since 2004 and the underdog is 9-1 ATS in the series and there have been 8 outright upsets in the last 9 meetings. The Under is also 11-3-1 between these two. GT has actually won their last 4 trips to Blacksburg. VT is 4-3 but they've won their last two including last week when they led BC 28-0 at half w/a 332-134 yd edge and won 42-21 (-7). RB Tuten has 811 (6.6). GT is 5-3 SU/ATS this season. Last week GT played w/o QB Haynes King and lost 31-13 (+13). Zach Pylon threw for 269 yards and a td but had 2 int's and RB Haynes was held to a ssn low 15 yards. VT has a big edge on ST's (#37 vs #112). All 11 of VT's wins in the last 2 years have been by 17 points or more and they are only laying 8' but series history overwhelmingly favors the away dog. We like still like VT by double-digits but if King plays then this will be a tighter game.

OHIO by 10 over Buffalo - The home team has dominated this series for years, going 11-2 SU/10-3 ATS and Ohio has won & covered their L4 meetings here in Athens. Ohio sits at 4-3 and are 2-1 in MAC play, but are off a 30-20 loss to Miami in a game they trailed 16-0 HT. Buffalo is also 2-1 in MAC play, which is a bit of a surprise, as they have beaten Toledo and NIU, but lost to WMich last week 48-41. Ohio is a run-first team, avg'g 191 ypg (5.0) led by RB Tyus (610, 5.4) and QB Navarro (427, 6.2) and face a Buffalo run D that allowed 209 (5.2) last week and vs UConn allowed 257 (5.6). Ohio is allowing just 266 ypg in MAC play and Buffalo's offense is putting up just 311 ypg incl just 184 ypg on the road. We'll back the series history & lean with the home tm.

APPALACHIAN ST by 14 over Georgia St - As SBC foes App St is 10-0 SU/7-2-1 ATS vs GSt with the avg win coming by 26 ppg. App St is off a bye week and sit at just 2-4 on the season. GSt is also 2-4 on the season, but App St still has time to turn their season around, while GSt is an inexp'd team going through a rebuild. GSt does have the #99 pass D (63%, 9-5) and QB Aguilar has had an extra week to prep and work on his 11-9 ratio and 55% completion rate. App St's rush attack (143, 4.3) should get going this week vs a GSt rush D allowing 217 ypg (5.3) over the L4 games. GSt's defense overall is allowing foes to gain 50 ypg above their season avg (#119 FBS). App St has played the tougher schedule (#63 vs #88) and is +15 ypg in SBC play while GSt is -46 ypg. Off a bye we feel like App St will have their best performance yet & win by 2 td's.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 21 over Kent St - Have not met since 2021 and in that game WMich (-6) put up 648 yds in a 64-31 win. WMich has started MAC play 3-0 and are putting up 446 ylg/42 ppg in conf play, but their defense is allowing 483 ypg/36 ppg in MAC play and overall are allowing foes to gain 140 ypg above their avg (#132 FBS)! However Kent St is even worse on D, allowing foes to gain 169 ypg above their season avg (#134 FBS!) and are allowing 538 ypg/46 ppg & their pass D ranks #133 (70%, 17-4 ratio). We expect WMich RB Nixon (596, 7.3) and QB Wolff (68%, 10-2 ratio) to take advantage of Kent's poor D, and they could be down to a true-frosh walk-on QB so there is no way we can lean Kent St and like the Broncos here by 3 td's.

SMU by 21 over DUKE - SMU is making their first trip to Durham since 1956. SMU is 6-1 and one of 3 unbeaten teams in ACC. The Mustangs have won their last 4 games including last week at Stanford 40-10 (-16). They are +122 ypg against our #62 sked while Duke is +21 ypg but they've only played our #98 sked. Duke's D leads the country in ffl's but SMU is #36 in ffl's allowed per gm (4.57). Duke is 6-1 but they've had four close wins. They trailed NC 20-0 3Q before a late rally and were outgained last week at home vs Florida St 291-180 but were +4 TO's and won 23-16 (-3). SMU beat that same FSU team 42-16 with a 458-285 yd edge. SMU is 6-3 as an away favorite under Lashlee and they have a huge edge on offense, putting up 52 ypg more than their foes allow while Duke avg 51 ypg less than their foes allow. Last week was Duke's first win in school history over FSU and we don't think they are nearly as good as their 6-1 record indicates while SMU enters on a roll.

MIAMI, OH by 17 over Central Michigan - MU has won the last 4 meetings and covered the last 5 vs CMich. Redhaws started 0-3 but have won 3 of their last 4 including a 30-20 (-3) win over Ohio last week. QB Brett Gabbert has a 9-1 ratio in their last 3 games and RB Keyon Mozee topped 100 in B2B games. CMich is 3-4 and +26 ypg but ply'd w/o starting QB Joey Labas last week. CMich led EMich 34-16 4Q then allowed 3 td's and lost by 4. MU is +27 ypg in MAC play while CMich is -34. They have two common foes with MU beating EMich by 24 (+89 yds) and Ohio by 10 (+37 yds) while CMich lost to Ohio by 2 (-132 yds) and EMich by 4 (-67 yds). Chuck Martin puts a big emphasis on home MAC games and they are 15-3 SU/12-6 ATS since '19. CMich is 25-13-1 as an away dog the last 10 years but we prefer the Redhaws at home, laying under 2 td's.

EAST CAROLINA by 10 over Temple - Temple leads the series 10-9 (6-3 ATS) but have dropped 3 straight. Last meeting ('22) Temple (+9) put up 575 yards of offense but let up a 89-8 touchdown drive to loss 49-46. Last week East Carolina (+17) was outgained 442-369 in a 45-28 loss at Army and fired HC Mike Houston after losing 4 of their last 5 games. The Pirates have been outgained in their last 5 games by an average of 125 yards. Temple started off 1-5 SU and 3-3 ATS but LW (-3) held Tulsa to just 245 yards and put up a ssn high 316 through the air in a 20-10 win. The under has hit 7 out of the last 9 matchups. The Owls are 4-14 ATS as an Away Dog (1-2 TY). Neither team has been impressive but we see this game coming down to Special Teams and East Carolina has the #2 group in the country so we will give them the edge.

KENTUCKY by 4 over Auburn - This is actually KY's final SEC home game. These two last met in the '20 Covid season and Auburn won 29-13 (-7) in front of no fans. The loser of this game is most likely sitting home for bowl season. KY is 3-4 and lost last week at Florida 48-20. The 'Cats held their first 6 foes to 251 ypg then allowed 476 last week. Auburn has had late leads against Oklahoma and Missouri but lost both games. KY is -39 ypg vs the SEC but they've played our #9 sked while Auburn is +44 ypg vs the SEC and has ply'd our #44 sked. KY has lost their last 6 SEC home games by 14 ppg (1-5 ATS) but Auburn is on a 2-10 SU/4-7-1 ATS and one of those wins was at Vandy last year. Auburn has better skill players including WR KeAndre Lambert-Smith (526, 20.2, 6 td's) but KY is better in the trenches and we will take KY by 4.

UCONN by 3 over Rice - Second meeting. Last year UConn (+10) trailed 14-0 into the 2Q then got a TD off a fumble, got a 50 yd fumble return TD and went 67-7 for a TD to led 20-14 at half, never trailed again in the game to win 38-31 thanks to being +4 in TO's. The Owls are 8-26 SU vs non-conference opponents since '16 but are 7-3 ATS coming off a SU loss the last 2 years. Last week, UConn (E) was held to just 40 yards (1.6 ypg) on the ground and were stopped on downs in their last drive to lose 23-20 vs Wake Forest. Rice (+22) despite being -5 in TO's were tied 10-10 heading into the 4Q but a FR TD and INT lost them the game 24-10 at Tulane. Rice is 8-27 SU on the road under Bloomgreen while UConn's Mora is 11-6 ATS at home. After beating UTSA and kept it close against Tulane we think Rice is better than their record so we will have them keeping it close.

ARKANSAS ST by 14 over Troy - Since 2017 Troy has won and covered 4 of the L5 meetings. However, Troy is struggling this season at just 1-6 with their lone win over FCS Florida A&M. Against FBS foes Troy is -98 ypg and their offense is putting up just 278 ypg. Ark St is at 4-3 on the year and are 2-1 in SBC play and are still in the conf title race. Last week QB Raynor got going finally after a 4-6 ratio in his F/6 games he had threw for 3 td's with 0 int's last week and the offense put up a season-best 467 yds. Ark St has the edge on offense (#86 vs #130) and are laying just around a td against a subpar Troy team and we feel like last week got Ark St's offense right and they will put up some yards & points on Troy's defense and win by 2 td's.

MICHIGAN by 6 over Michigan St - After going 8-30 from 1970-2007 in the series, Michigan St has won 10 of the last 16 meetings (13-3 ATS). Last time here ('22) the Spartans (+22) only trailed 13-7 at half but were shutout in the 2H falling 29-7. Last year Michigan (-24) outgained MSU 477-182 and had a +18 FD edge, winning 49-0 which is largest MOV in the history of the rivalry. After dropping three straight MSU got back in the win column last week vs Iowa. Spartans (+6) rushed for a season high 212 yds and held the Hawkeyes to 283 yds in a 32-20 win. Michigan has dropped two straight games for the first time s/20. The Wolverines (-4) were only down 13-7 at half but were shutout in the 2H losing 21-7 with the 322-267 yards edge. Michigan has won 17 straight home conference games so we see them continuing the streak here.

TCU by 13 over Texas Tech - TCU has won and covered 3 of the L4 games vs TT. TCU is off a 13-7 road win at Utah where they put up 395 yds, which was 104 yds more than Utah had been allowing per game. TT did host Baylor last week and their defense allowed 529 yds and 59 pts. TT does have the #78 pass D (62%, 15-8) and is allowing 321 ypg (62%) over the L4 games. TT faces a TCU pass attack led by QB Hoover (69%, 16-6) and WR's Bech and Savion Williams. TCU's defense is holding foes to 337 ypg over the L4 games and are holding B12 foes to 91 ypg under their season avg. While TT QB Morton is hitting 64% (17-3) he faces the #36 pass D here (55%, 10-4). With TCU having the big defensive edge (#45 vs #108) and coming off an impressive road win, we'll back the Horned Frogs here by 2 scores.

SOUTH ALABAMA by 13 over ULM - SALA has won 3 of the L4 meetings SU and last season won 55-7. ULM sits at 5-1 on the season under 1st year HC Vincent but the offense put up 300+ yds for the first time against an FBS foe in their last game vs SMiss (432 yds) and on the season are only gaining 280 ypg. SALA is 3-4, but are 2-1 in SBC play. SALA is putting up 445 ypg on offense led by QB Lopez (65%, 13-1 ratio) and the defense is allowing just 289 ypg/14 ppg in SBC play. Against Troy this ssn SALA was +146 yds and won by 16 pts while ULM was -25 yds and won by 4 pts. SALA is +56 ypg on the season while ULM is -64 ypg and they have played around the same schedule strength (#109 ULM, #111 SALA). ULM does struggle to stop the run (193, 4.6 allowed L4 gms) and SALA RB Bothwell (461, 6.8) could have a big game. We feel like SALA is the better team and at home we like them over ULM by nearly 2 td's.

TEXAS A&M by 10 over Lsu - These teams have split 6 meetings. The underdog is 3-0-1 ATS. Both teams dropped their opener but have won all six games since. LSU is #8 and +92 ypg. Last week LSU was -3 at Arkansas and won 34-10 with a 393-277 yd edge. A&M is #14 and +80 ypg. Last week they were -19' at Miss St and only won 34-24. Aggies won their last home game in impressive fashion, beating Mizzou 41-10 with a 512-254 yd edge. LSU had an emotional home win two weeks ago over Ole Miss and is playing their 2nd straight road game. A&M has the edge on defense and ST's and the Aggies are on an 11-2 SU run at home including a 38-23 win as 10 pt dogs against LSU LTH. The situation favors A&M greatly with LSU playing their 2nd straight road game and LSU is 4-11 ATS away from home under Kelly so we will take the Aggies by two scores.

Utah by 3 over HOUSTON - HOU is 4-0 all-time vs Utah but have not met since 1978! After a 4-0 strat Utah has dropped 3 straight games as they have struggled to score points (12 ppg in L/3 gms) and are avg'g just 327 ypg in their L/3 games. HOU is just 2-4 on the season and last week we went against them at Kansas (3★ LP winner on KU!) and they lost QB Chriss to inj in 1H and they allowed 467 yds and were -4 TO's in a 42-14 loss. HOU's offense is avg'g just 293 ypg in B12 play but their defense is holding foes to 144 ypg under their season avg (#4 FBS!). Utah is also playing strong defense as they are holding foes to 95 ypg under their season avg (#17 FBS). This will be a defensive battle and we will call for Utah by 3 but that is at the line as it is impossible for us to trust this Utah team to cover any line as a favorite with the state of their offense currently.

OLE MISS by 19 over Oklahoma - Only prior meeting was in the 1999 Independence Bowl. Oklahoma is a 20 pt dog for the first time since 1997. The Sooners are 4-3 but have lost 3 of their last 4 and are -112 ypg in SEC play. Last week they were down 21-0 vs SCar just 5 minutes into the game thanks to 2 defensive td's. Jackson Arnold is getting a 2nd chance and does have an 8-3 ratio. The Sooners D only allows 326 ypg and is holding foes 76 ypg below their avg. Ole Miss is fresh off a bye and 2 weeks ago let their game slip away at LSU in a 29-26 loss. The week prior Ole Miss beat that same SCar team 27-3 on the road. Rebels are at home and their defense matches Oklahoma's, plus the Rebels have a huge edge on offense, putting up 561 ypg while OK avg just 288 ypg. Still it's hard to lay this many points against OK.

BAYLOR by 10 over Oklahoma St - Oklahoma St has won and covered 3 of the past 4 meetings vs Baylor. Oklahoma St is off to an 0-4 start in B12 play and are -156 ypg/-13 ppg in conf play. Okla St did show some life last week at BYU, as they ran for 269 (7.3) and nearly pulled the outright upset. Baylor got their first B12 win last week at Tex Tech, as they put up 529 yds in a 59-35 win. Oklahoma St is back to QB Bowman after switching to Rangel (out with inj). Okla St's run defense has been shredded, giving up 298 ypg (6.7) in B12 play, and Baylor just ran for 255 (7.7) a week ago against a better defense. Baylor HC Aranda is a great defensive mind and will be looking to slow down Oklahoma St RB Gordon, as he is what makes their offense go. Baylor is allowing 160 rush ypg (3.8) on the season. Oklahoma St has taken major inj's on defense and it shows, so we like Baylor here.

San Jose St over FRESNO ST - SJSt has lost 4 of the L/6 gms vs Fresno, but LY SJSt picked up a 42-18 win at home (+151 yds, +2 TO's). SJSt has been a surprise in the MW this season, and sit at 5-2 on the season. The L/4 games the Spartans are avg'g 470 ypg and are throwing for 343 ypg. Fresno is at 4-3 and snapped a 2 gm losing streak last week at Nevada, but only won by 3 pts and trailed at the half. Fresno's offense is only its avg'g 336 ypg the L/4 games and QB Keene has just an 8-9 ratio and SJSt is allowing 359 ypg in MW play. SJSt has a great duo at WR in Nash (904, 12.6) and Lockhart (532, 18.3) and Fresno's secondary has allowed 249 ypg (66%) in MW play. We have been impressed with the Spartans and think they go on the road and get the outright upset!

Tulane by 8 over NORTH TEXAS - Third meeting, first trip to Denton. Tulane won the previous two meetings (1-1 ATS). Last year the Wave (-20) led 21-0 with a 274-128 yard edge but allowed NT to score on their first 4 possessions in the 2H then scored a GW TD with 2:34 left. Both teams come into this matchup with a 5-2 record. Last week, Tulane (-22) headed into HT with a 10-7 lead with Rice and were able to get two 4Q td's to win 24-10. North Texas (+11) outgained Memphis 653-526 and held the 4Q lead 38-35 but gave up B2B TD drives then threw an INT at the Memphis 18 to end the game losing 52-44. The Mean Green are 13-7 ATS off a SU loss and 10-6 ATS as conf dog s/21. Tulane is holding their foes to 101 yds below their ssn avg (#13) while NT is going for 147 yds above what their foes are allowing (#5). Tulane has the defensive edge (#28 vs #129) but NT has been hard to stop so we will put this right at the line and see where it goes.

ALABAMA by 21 over Missouri - Bama started 4-0 and were #1 after being Georgia but they've lost two of their last 3. In the meantime Missouri is 6-1 and +149 ypg but only played their #100 sked strength and are 2 td underdogs. Mizzou has bullied their non-conference foes (+44 ppg/+356 ypg) but have struggled vs P4 foes (-4 ppg/+17 ypg). Bama does have a 32 point win at Wisconsin and beat Georgia and South Carolina at home, and they've taken on our #2 toughest sked. Hard to explain the road losses but Bama is has won 19 straight SEC home games (13-5-1 ATS) by 20.6 ppg. Under Drinkwitz, Mizzou is 7-14 SU/11-10 ATS on the road. This is now a desperate Bama team that must win out to make the playoffs and we think the Tide roll here by 3 td's.

MEMPHIS by 13 over Charlotte - Second meeting. Their first meeting last year went to OT. Charlotte (+10') held the 38-28 4Q lead but let up a TD and a FG then in OT missed a FG to fall 44-38. Memphis dropped their first AAC game but came back off a bye to beat USF and North Texas. LW, the Tigers (-11') scored on their last four possessions (3 TD and a FG) to pull out a 52-44 win. Charlotte opened up 1-3 but then got two upset wins over Rice and East Carolina. Last week, 49ers (+16') held Navy to 177 yards below their ssn average but that was due to short possessions and being -5 in turnovers in a 51-17 loss. Memphis HC Ryan Silverfield is 25-7 SU at home but just 8-14-1 ATS as a HF. CLT HC Poggi is 7-2 ATS as an AD and have been looking better as of recent so we will go with the 49ers to keep it within the line.

Texas by 17 over VANDERBILT - Texas and Vandy meet for the first time since 1928 but no one could have predicted Vandy coming in on a 3 game winning streak having beaten Bama, KY and Ball St. Texas was #1 coming into last week but lost their first big SEC test to Georgia 30-15. UT was held to 38 yards in the 1st half and trailed 23-0. Diego Pavia has led Vandy to their best start 2008. Pavia actually has a better QB rating than QB Ewers. Vandy was in a clear flat spot last week vs Ball St but they are +105 ypg at home while Texas is +224 ypg and already won in the Big House this year. The Longhorns have a huge edge on D, holding foes 185 ypg below their avg (#1 in FBS) while Vandy only holds foes 5 ypg below their avg (#80 in FBS). We can't lay 18 points against this scrappy Vandy team but also can't call for Vandy to keep it a whole lot closer.

Arkansas by 10 over MISSISSIPPI ST - Miss St has won the last two meetings but last year's game was a painful 7-3 affair. The Hogs are 4-3 but coming off a 34-10 home loss to LSU where they were held to a ssn low 277 yards. QB Taylen Green is hitting 58% but just a 6-6 ratio and Ark has allowed 17 sacks in their last 6 games. Miss St is 1-6 this ssn but has covered 3 straight. QB Michael Van Buren has a 6-2 ratio despite facing 3 of the best defenses in the country in Texas, Georgia and A&M. Last week the Bulldogs had a 273-180 yard edge at half and only lost to A&M 34-24 as 19 point dogs. Miss St has taken on our #12 sked. Ark did win at Auburn and led OKSt 21-0. The Hogs need a win here to put themselves in good shape for a bowl and are out for legit revenge. Miss St is clearly improving but the Hogs will bounce back and hand the Bulldogs their 7th straight loss.

Utah by 17 over TULSA - First meeting as AAC foes. UTSA was a conference favorite heading into the season but are 3-4 overall and 1-2 in conf play. The Roadrunners looked like they turned things around last week, as they were tied 17-17 with a 234-174 yards edge but in the 2H UTSA outgained the Owls 251-29 and won 38-24 (-6'). UTSA did get to the QB 7 times in the game. Tulsa (+3) put up a season low on offense 245 yards in a 20-10 loss at Temple. UTSA is +134 ypg in conference play while Tulsa is -190 yards and their losses have been by 42, 32 and 10 in conference play. UTSA is 26-2 SU and has covered 10 of the last 16 as conference favorites along with being 9-3 as an AF. Tulsa is 8-18 ATS as a home underdog since 2011. The Roadrunners are trending in the right direction as QB McCown threw for 340 yds LW while Tulsa has not been impressive so we will go with UTSA to get the cover on the road.

COLORADO by 3 over Cincinnati - A battle between two unlikely Big 12 contenders. Cincy enters this game 5-2 on the season, with both losses coming by a total of 4 pts. Last week we won both a 4★ play on these pages, plus a 3★ LP play on the Bearcats (-5') as they beat Ariz St 24-14. Colorado is quieting critics by the week and are 5-2 this season, plus are off a 34-7 win at Ariz where they had a 398-245 yd edge. Colorado is getting strong play from their DLine, as they are allowing 159 rush (3.9) and have 21 sks including 16 sks the L/3 games! Cincy does have a strong rush attack led by RB's Kiner (598, 5.6) and Pryor (307, 9.9), plus their OL has allowed 11 sks. Cincy does have the #81 pass D and faces a strong pass attack led by QB Sanders and WR/CB Hunter is healthier after sitting 2H last week. While we feel like Colorado wins here, Cincy has been cover machines for us and the line is creeping closer to a td as the week goes on.

Utah St by 3 over WYOMING - Wyoming has covered 5 of the L/6 meetings vs Utah St. The Aggies have yet to beat an FBS foe this season and sit at just 1-6. USU's offense isn't the issue, as they are putting up 518 ypg the L/4 games incl 372 pass ypg. Wyoming is also just 1-6 on the season as their offense is putting up 107 ypg less than their foes allow (#131 FBS) and their defense is allowing foes to gain 56 ypg above their season average (#113 FBS). Wyoming has the #101 pass D as they are allowing 61% and have a 10-4 ratio. Utah St QB Petras has thrown for 1,486 yards (10-5 ratio) in the L/4 games. Wyoming's offense has shown improvement in MW play (366 ypg/23 ppg) and USU is allowing foes to gain 117 ypg above their season average (#130 FBS). We feel like USU's offense will make enough plays and win a high-scoring game by a fg.

West Virginia by 7 over ARIZONA - First meeting. After opening 2-0 in Big 12 play WVU has dropped 2 in a row to Iowa St and Kan St at home. Arizona has dropped 4 of their last 5 games including 3 straight B12 games. Last week they lost 34-7 at home and only put up 245 yds. Arizona

is just 1-6 ATS and 3 of their L/4 losses and have lost their top LB and their starting LT for the season plus QB Fifta is hitting just 59% with a 9-10 ratio and after 304 yds in the opener WR McMillian has 476 yards in his past 6 games. WVU does have RB's White & Donaldson but are waiting to see the status of their QB Greene, who left last week with inj. The new QB would be Nicco Marchiol who has experience. WVU does hold foes to 63 ypg under their season avg. Given Ariz's struggles covering games, we like WVU to go to Tucson and get the outright win.

CALIFORNIA by 10 over Oregon St - Former Pac-12 foes meet for the first time since 1905 as non-conf foes. OSU has won 4 of the last 5 meetings. Last year OSU won 52-40 (-7'). Cal was 3-0 but has lost 4 straight heart breakers by a combined 9 points. They've led Miami by 25 3Q and last week they led NCSt 23-10 but all'd two 4Q td's then missed the GW fg. OSU is 4-3 under 1st year HC Trent Bray but they've lost two straight and have failed to cover their L/3. Bears are +34 ypg against our #34 sked while Oregon St is +59 ypg against our #89 sked. Cal reminded us why we can't trust them as favorites last week but Oregon St is equally frustrating so we are putting this at the line.

Washington St by 10 over SAN DIEGO ST - 3rd meeting, last met in 2011 here in San Diego where SDSU won 42-24. The Aztecs are off a bye and won their past 2 games each by the score of 27-24. WSU is now sitting at 6-1 and are off a 42-10 win vs Hawaii where they were +144 yds and +3 TO's. SDSU has been getting better production from their pass rush as they have 20 sacks in their last 4 games. WSU's offense is led by QB Mateer (60%, 16-6, 533 rush, 5.2) and they are putting 78 ypg above what their foes allow (#27 FBS) but SDSU is allowing 375 ypg. WSU's defense is allowing 426 ypg and SDSU's offense is led by RB Cooper (670, 4.4) and QB O'Neil is hitting 62% with a 6-1 ratio. While we think WSU wins the game, they are laying around 2 td's and we think the Aztecs at home will be able to keep the game within that line.

Wake Forest by 3 over STANFORD - WF travels over 2,300 miles for their farthest ACC game. Deacons ended a 7 game ACC road losing streak at NCSt earlier this year then won 23-20 at UConn last week. Stanford has lost four straight by 3 ppg and -174 ypg but those four losses did come against four very good teams (Clem, VT, ND, SMU). Stanford benched QB Ashton Daniels last week. WF has a big edge on offense here, avg 397 ypg while SU avg just 299 and is putting up 54 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. While this is a tough travel for WF, Stanford is hardly a difficult road environment and the Deacons still have a shot at a bowl. Stanford is on a 5-13 ATS run as a home dog s/21 but Clawson is just 5-11 as a road favorite. WF is laying 3 points and we think the Deacons win a close game.

Penn St by 3 over WISCONSIN - Penn St has won and covered the last five matchups. Last meeting (21), PSU forced 3 To's including two in the final 2:00 in a 16-10 win. Wisconsin played great 1H's vs Alabama and USC but opened 2-2 then blew out Purdue and Rutgers by 40.5 ppg. Last week, Wisconsin (-9') had their 5th game of the year holding their foe to below 300 yds (3rd straight) and dominated Northwestern 23-3. Penn St is coming off a bye and needed an OT to beat USC on the road. Nittany Lions (-3') went down 20-6 at H but outgained the Trojans 308-164 in the 2H to come-back 33-30. Wisconsin is coming off 3 straight ATS wins and Penn St has lost 3 straight ATS and has Ohio St on deck so we will take the Badgers to keep it close at home.

IOWA by 14 over Northwestern - Iowa leads the series 54-28-3. The Hawkeyes have won 3 of the last 4. Last time here (22) Wildcats (+11') were held to a season-low 177 yards of offense and were -221 in total yards falling to Iowa 33-13. Last year at Wrigley Field, Iowa (-5) held the Wildcats again to a season low 170 yards but needed to kick a game-winning field goal with :14 left.

Iowa RB Johnson has 100 yards and a TD in 6 of his last 7 games. Both teams have solid run defenses Northwestern is allowing 3.2 ypc (#17) and Iowa 3.7 (#29). Iowa is coming off a 32-20 (-6') loss to Michigan St where they were outgained 468-283. NW (+9') were -150 net yds in a 23-3 loss to Wisconsin. Iowa beat Washington 40-16 in their last home while NW lost to Wash 24-5 on the road. Our lean is right at the line as both teams have struggled so we will see where this goes.

OHIO ST by 28 over Nebraska - Nebraska won the first meeting as B10 foes in '11 but Ohio St has won 7 straight (5-2 ATS). In their last meeting (21), the Buckeyes (-14') put up 405 yards through the air but settled for field goals in the 2H to win 26-17. Nebraska is coming off a very disappointing loss. The Huskers (+6') were gashed for 215 yds (6.5) on the ground and turned the ball over 5 times in a 56-7 blowout loss to Indiana. Ohio St is coming off a bye and played a tough road game at Oregon in their previous game. Buckeyes (-3') traded scores with the Ducks but QB Howard decided to run the ball to try to set up a GW FG but the clock hit :00 and lost 32-31. OSU HC Day is 23-14 ATS as a home favorite and they did beat a stronger Iowa team 35-7 in their last home game. Nebraska HC Rhules is 20-10 ATS as an AD. OSU has faced the tougher schedule, #33 vs #102 and the Buckeyes are fired up after losing on the road so expect a win by 4 td's here.

OREGON by 28 over Illinois - Fourth meeting, first since '95. Illinois is off their biggest win of the season and this is pure let down situation as they were outgained (322-267) last week vs Michigan. The Illini (+4') benefitted from three Michigan turnovers scoring 10 points off them in a 21-7 home win. Now Illinois is going to the west coast facing a Oregon team that is off Purdue. The Ducks (-29') outgained the Boilermakers 421-301 in a 35-0 shutout road win. Oregon QB Dillon Gabriel is hitting at 77% with a 15-4 ratio while Illinois has the #62 pass eff D allowing 61%. The Ducks are holding foes to 116 yards below their average (#9) and the offense is putting up 114 ypg above opponents averages (#13). Oregon is 7-3 as a 20+ point conference favorite the last three years we will go with them to continue their dominance by 4 td's at home!

Nevada by 1 over HAWAII - Hawaii has won and covered 4 of the L/5 meetings and since 2016 the underdog has pulled the outright upset in 7 of the 8 meetings. The last 11 meetings have all gone 'Under' the Vegas total (avg of 49 ppg). Nev QB Lewis is hitting 67% and has a 10-5 ratio, plus the 'Pack are rushing for 205 ypg (5.3). Hawaii's defense has allowed over 400 yds each of the L/2 games and are giving up 166 rush ypg (4.4) in MW play. On offense, Hawaii is putting up 89 ypg under what their foes allow (#125 FBS) and Nev is holding MW foes to 27 ypg under their season avg. Hawaii has yet to beat an FBS team this season, but have given UCLA and Boise St good games at home so we think they keep this game close & another upset in this series wouldn't shock us.

JAX's pass defense is awful as they are allowing 274 ypg and 71% on the season and GB Love is hitting 62% but does have a 15-8 ratio and threw 2 int's last week that set up HOU's only 2 td drives. GB's OL has only allowed 11 sks so he should have more time to throw and avoid mistakes. GB does allow just 115 rush ypg (4.3) and they held HOU QB Stroud to just 86 yds! JAX's defense is allowing foes to gain 86 ypg above their season avg (#32 NFL) while GB's offense is putting up 62 ypg more than their foes allow (#3 NFL). GB also has a solid pass rush (20 sks) and will give QB Lawrence headaches. JAX is likely sluggish off their trip back from London and GB's offense will have a field day against a bad JAX secondary.

TEN's DEF gave up a ssn-high 389 yds LW at BUF (315 pass yds) now face an even better offense here. DET is avg'g 412 ypg and are rushing for 156 ypg (4.9). DET QB Goff is hitting 83% the L/4 games. On DEF Detroit is allowing 338 ypg overall & their run D allows just 93 ypg (4.6). DET is t-#3 in TO margin in the NFL (+6) while TEN is #31 NFL in TO margin (-9). DET is on a 9-1 ATS run overall and are 11-5 ATS as a HF since '22 and even with the spread at DD's we don't mind backing the red-hot Lions at home.

Minnesota vs LA RAMS - TNF - With MIN's loss last Sun there is only 1 unbeaten team left in the NFL. MIN went up 10-0, then trailed 21-10, came back to lead 29-28 before losing 31-29. LAR picked up their 2nd win of the season vs Las Vegas despite putting up just 259 yds (+3 TO's). MIN has a strong run defense (80, 4.0) and they have 24 sacks this ssn. LAR does allow 212 pass ypg (64%) and MIN QB Darnold is hitting 67% with a 12-5 ratio and WR's Jefferson & Addison will give LAR's DB's a fit. LAR does also allow 152 rush ypg (4.7) and last week MIN RB Jones was back & MIN ran for 139 (6.6). MIN's offense does struggle at times to protect the QB (19 sks all'd) and MIN travels out West on a short week. **Call the office on Thur after Noon for the Marquee Winner!**

Baltimore by 14 over CLEVELAND - BAL is the NFL's hottest team (5-0 SU/ATS run) and are off a 41-31 win at TB where they put up 508 yds. CLE is off their 5th straight loss where they lost QB Watson for the ssn & bkp DTR was also banged up so the starter could be Jamies Winston. CLE did finally top 300 yds in a game but their OL is still banged up & have allowed 35 sks & BAL's pass rush could have a big day (22 sks in '24). BAL does allow 67% but CLE's pass offense is a weakness, and BAL will stop the run (allowing just 68 ypg, 3.3 ypc). LY BAL won here 28-3 and they are better than LY and CLE is in worse shape. BAL's rush attack (211, 6.2) will have a big day and QB Jackson has a 12-1 ratio the L/4 games (71%). Despite the line approaching DD's we think this is a complete mismatch and like the Ravens by 2 td's.

HOUSTON by 7 over Indianapolis - HOU enters this AFC South clash 5-2 and already have a 29-27 win over IND in week 1 where HOU was +114 yds. After starting 0-2 IND has won 4 of 5 gms, but all by 1 score. IND's pass defense has had issues, allowing 332 to CHI and 371 to JAX this ssn, so this could be a "get right" game for HOU's pass offense, that struggled vs GB (86 yds). HOU's defense is holding foes to 54 ypg under their season avg (#3 NFL) and are allowing just 277 ypg. HOU RB Mixon has ran for B2B 100+ yd gms since returning from inj & vs IND in the opener ran for 159 (5.3). While we feel like HOU is the better team, every game for Indy this season has been decided by 1 score or less and 5 of 7 gms for HOU have been decided by 6 pts or less.

MIAMI by 6 over Arizona - ARZ has to travel to the East Coast on short rest here after a last-second MON night win over LAC 17-15. MIA lost QB Huntley and had to resort to Tim Boyle at QB last week at Indy, but still their defense kept them in the game, allowing just 284 yds. MIA's defense is allowing just 285 ypg and ARZ is gaining just 321 ypg the L/4 gms and WR Harrison hasn't topped 50 yds in any of the L/4 gms. ARZ does run the ball well (150, 5.5) but MIA allows just 131 (4.6). We will lean with MIA assuming Tua plays because if he plays we give MIA a good shot to win and we like the situation for MIA, but their QB situation without Tua is murky and ARZ would have a much better shot at a victory if he is unable to play this week.

Chicago by 4 over WASHINGTON - A battle of 2 of the most surprising teams in the NFL this season. Prior to their bye CHI won & covered 3 straight games. WAS won 40-7 last week vs CAR but lost stud QB Daniels to a rib injury (? here, check status). WAS has backup Mariotta, but not having Daniels changes the dynamic of this offense. CHI is getting great play from QB Williams (263 ypg, 70% L/4 gms) and CHI is running the ball better (137, 4.3) the L/3 gms. CHI is also holding tms to 292 ypg and are allowing just 112 rush ypg (4.6) and 180 pass ypg. Obviously the wildcard here is QB Daniels, if he is unable to go that changes this matchup. CHI has the better defense and we will lean with them here well-rested off a bye week.

NY Jets by 8 over NEW ENGLAND - The Jets lone impressive win of the season came vs NE back in week 3, when they won 24-3 as they put up 400 yds and held NE to 139 yds. NYJ has dropped 4 straight games and are avg'g just 305 ypg/15 ppg in their L/4 gms. Meanwhile the defense has slipped a bit and last Sun night allowed the Steelers to gain 409 yds & score 37 pts. NE has made the switch to rookie QB Maye and he threw for 257 yds last week but NE lost by 16 pts and NE has dropped 6 in a row. The offense is avg'g just 275 ypg/15 ppg their L/4 games. NE is allowing a respectable 360 ypg overall but are allowing 68% completions. While we feel like the Jets will get on track here, we have ZERO confidence leaning strongly with them (0-4 ATS run).

Buffalo by 10 over SEATTLE - Buffalo comes out West riding a 2 gm winning streak, and sit at 5-2 overall, while SEA returns home after a 34-14 win at ATL where the Seahawks snapped a 3 game losing skid. SEA could be playing here w/o star WR Metcalf (hamstring). BUF made a move to get WR Amari Cooper and he looks like a good fit early in Buffalo, giving that team a true #1 WR, something that was missing from BUF. After throwing 18 int's last season, BUF QB Allen has a 12-0 ratio and is hitting 63%. SEA is allowing 73% completions the L/4 gms and their
