COLLEGE SELECTIONS TEAM IN

4★ Texas A&M over South Carolina - A&M is 8-0 SU and has covered the L/4 mtgs. The Aggies have also dominated the L/2 mtgs, winning 48-3 LTH and last year we cashed our 5★ Oct GOM on A&M when they annihilated SCar 44-14 (-19) and at one point had a 473-10 yd edge. Both tms are fresh off a bye. SCar has won 3 straight but those have come over CLT, FCS SCar St and KY who was w/o QB Levis. A&M nearly upset Barna prior to their bye, getting to the Barna 2 on the final play, losing 24-20 (+24). The Aggies are -32 ypg while SC is +35 ypg but A&M has faced the much tougher sked (#6 vs #53). A&M has the edge on D, holding foes 84 ypg below their avg. After last year's dominating performance we can't help but throw the Aggies in the mix for our October 5★ GOM!

FORECAST: Texas A&M by 14 3★ Kansas St over TCU - KSt has covered 6 of the L/7 mtgs vs TCU and 5 of those covers were as an underdog and there were 3 outright upsets by KSt including the last time here. KSt has the rest as an underdog and triber were 3 outlight upbest by KSt including the last time here. KSt has the rest edge here as they are off a bye week, while TCU just played Okla St and won a thrilling 43-40 game in 2 OT. While TCU comes in avg'g 543 ypg/45 ppg vs B12 foes, they are facing a KSt defense that is holding tms to 62 ypg under their ssn avg & the KSt pass rush is capable of getting to the QB. This is also the best pass D TCU QB Duggan has faced as KSt's pass D ranks #10 as they have all your control of the CB. The standard of the control of t 7 td's and have 9 int's. TCU's defense has been suspect at time, allowing 427 ypg vs B12 foes and the KSt offense, led by QB Martinez and RB Vaughn, has come to life in B12 play as they are gaining 99 ypg above than their foes allow in conference play. KSt is already 2-0 SU on the road in B12 play TY and we think they make it 3-0 win an upset win here.

FORECAST: Kansas St by 3 3★ Cincinnati over SMU - CIN is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in the series, incl a 48-14 (-10') home win LY when the #3 ranked Bearcats outg'd the Mustangs 544-199! CIN is off a bye & has won 18 str AAC gms dating back to '19. They did struggle their last time out, in a 28-24 (-27') home win over conf bottom dwellar USF. QB Bryant left in 4Q with an inj, so something to keep an eye on here. The Bearcats Def is all'g just 313 ypg & is #6 in the nation with 23 sks. SMU is off a 40-34 (-12') win over Navy. The Mustangs led 33-14 entering the 4Q, but all'd 2 TDs in the last 3 mins to make it appear closer than it actually was Despite the win, SMU is on an 0-4 ATS run & CIN has extra rest, and we will take a Fickell led squad that has won big games before over a 1st year head coach. FORECAST: Cincinnati by 11

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ SAN DIEGO ST over Nevada - Nev has covered the L/4 mtgs against SDSt. Despite some struggles the Aztecs are 3-3 on the ssn and still very much in the mix to contend in the MW. SDSt only avg 284 ypg/19 ppg and their D is allowing 394 ypg. However, they face a Nev team that is gaining just 292 ypg & scoring just 17 ppg in MW play. Nev is also allowing their foes to gain 51 ypg above their ssn avg (#116 FBS). SDSt had a week off to evaluate and make changes while Nev is off a 31-16 loss at Hawaii. Nev's 2 wins came when they were +9 in TO's the F/2 gms, but in their L/5 gms they have no TO margin edge & have lost 4 of their L/5 gms by 14 or more points. We see the Aztecs winning by 2 td's and they are only laying 7 pts.

FORECAST: SAN DIEGO ST by 14

2★ UTEP over Fau - FAU has won the last 2 meetings including LY 28-25 but the Miners covered as 11 pt dogs. FAU did lead 28-10 4Q and rallied with 2 td's in the final 2:50 for a backdoor cover. UTEP enters fresh off a bye and the week prior they had a misleading loss to LA Tech where they held a 501-380 yd edge and the game swung on TO's and UTEP was SOD twice in the 1H. FAU beat Rice 17-14 (-4) last week. UTEP is holding foes 22 ypg below their avg and they have 7 sks in their last 2 gms. FAU is just 2-11 SU on the road under Taggart and UTEP is 9-3 SU at home the L3Y including a 17 pt win over Boise this year so we like the Miners as a dog here!

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 19TH

Georgia St at APPALACHIAN ST - As SBC foes App St is 8-0 SU vs GSt (5-2-1 ATS) and have won by an avg of 25 ppg. Both tms last played 11 days ago and App St is off a shocking 36-24 loss at TXSt (-19) where they trailed 24-3 HT (-134 yds) and the got a TD on the final play of the gm to make the gm look closer. After their 0-4 start, GSt has won 2 gms in a row and last beat GSthm 41-33 at home (+70 yds, +3 TO). App St has a solid rush D, giving up just 126 ypg (3.5) and their DEF is holding foes to 55 ypg under their ssn avg. However GSt's rush offense has been steady all season, avg'g 234 ypg (5.0) incl rushing for 335 yds (6.2) in their last gm. GSt's DEF is all'g 464 ypg in their L/4 gms while App St is avg'g 450 ypg on offense led by QB Brice (1668, 66%, 18-3), but App St is just 5-10 ATS as a HF under HC Clark and GSt is 6-3 ATS as an AD since 2020.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 20TH
Virginia at GEORGIA TECH - The home team is 19-4 SU/17-5-1 in this series. UVA has won the L/2. LY the 'Hoos trailed 16-7 2Q but led 48-27 before GT added two td's in the final 1:16. The Jackets are 2-0 since firing Geoff Collins and promoting GT alum Brent Key. Prior to the bye GT outgained Duke 412-278 but needed OT to win 23-20 (-3). UVA is off a bye after 3 straight losses. They lost at home by 17 to Louisville who was w/o QB Cunningham and was outgained 473-319. UVÁ also lost at Duke by 21 and finished with just 295 yds. GT is holding foes 86 ypg below their avg (#18 in FBS) while UVA is holding foes 36 ypg below their avg (#44 FBS). This is a must win for GT to reach a bowl. Troy at SOUTH ALABAMA - Battle for the Belt! After only going 1-4-1 ATS in their F/6 mtgs, Troy has won & covered the L/4 games in this series. The last game in Mobile Troy was +175 yds and shut out SAla, winning 29-0. Both teams are off short rest as Troy hosted TXSt and hung on to win 17-14 while delivering a 4.5★ Totals GOM Winner on the Under 47 while SAla was up 41-20 on ULM 4Q but ULM had two 4Q td's to make it 41-34. This is a matchup of 2 great defenses as Troy is giving up 341 ypg and are holding tms to 96 ypg under their ssn avg (#16) while SAIa is giving up just 299 ypg and are holding foes to 79 ypg under their ssn avg (#22), but Troy has taken on the tougher schedule (#71 vs #97). Both tms also have top 40 pass DEF's (SAIa #19, Troy #36). Troy is playing for an 8th straight week here while SAla recently had a bye week. While Troy is 5-1 ATS vs foes TY, the Jags come in 4-1 ATS in SBC home games under Wommack.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 21ST

Tulsa at TEMPLE - 1st mtg at Temple s/18. Tulsa won 44-10 (-22) at home LY as they outg'd the Owls 513-293. Tulsa have lost 3 str (2-1 ATS), but are coming off a bye. In their last outing, they were thumped by Navy 53-21 (-6) as they all'd 455 rush yds (6.6 ypc) to Navy's option attack. The Tulsa OL has also struggled the L2W, all'g 13 sks, incl 11 to ClN a few wks ago. For the year, Tulsa is avg 46 more yds than the opps allow (#48), but is all'g 34 yds more than the opps gain (#104). Temple is off a 70-13 (+23') than the hands of UCF. The Owls actually had leads of 3-0 & 10-7 in IQ, but

off a 70-13 (+23) thrashing at the hands of UCF. The Owls actually had leads of 3-0 & 10-7 in 1Q, but trailed 35-13 at HT & all'd 56 unanswered pts after pulling within 14-13 mid 2Q. The Temple D was all'g just 258 ypg & had 19 sks the 4 gms prior to this one, but UCF amassed 737 thl yds, incl 304 (7.4) on the ground. The Owls are 2-0 ATS at home this yr while Tulsa is 0-2 ATS as an AF. **Uab at WKU -** These two last met in '20 when UAB was at home and won 37-14 (-12) but they lost LTH in '19 when UAB held WKU to 222 yds but were -3 TO's and lost 20-13 (-3). WKU had a 245-121 yd edge at half but only led 14-10. They pulled away in the 2H & won 35-17. UAB outrushed CLT 279-113 last week in a 34-20 win. UAB actually trailed at half 14-10 despite being 23' pt fav but they did finish with 510-327 yd & 27-12 FD edges. 'Toppers QB Reed has a 21-5 ratio and WKU hasn't

allowed a sack in their last 2 games but UAB has our #3 ranked pass D, allowing just a 4-9 ratio and Reed has faced our #36, #84, #93, #96, #106 & #110 pass D's. UAB has the edge on D while WKU has the edge on offense. WKU is 8-2-1 ATS vs CUSA foes.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 22ND

ARMY by 6 over UIm - Only other mtg came in 2020 where Army won easily 37-7 (+268 yds). Army comes into this gm with 2 with, but both against FCS foes while ULM was at SAla last wk and trailed 41-20 early 4Q but scored 2 td's to get the cover and now are back on the road. Army's option is putting up 317 rush ypg (5.8), but the ULM rush DEF has done well this ssn. If you take out their game vs Bama (all'd 273 rush, 7.0 ypc) they have all'd just 130 ypg (3.7) against their other 6 foes. ULM's offense comes in avg'g just 336 ypg, but the Army DEF is giving up 473 ypg/39 ppg vs FBS foes & ULM did put up 438 yds vs a good SAIa DEF. Army has also had issues with TO's, as they are -7 TO's vs FBS foes. While we see Army getting the win, the Black Knights are 0-4 ATS TY against FBS foes and this Warhawks team under HC Bowden is a scrappy bunch.

MIAMI, FL by 13 over Duke - UM won the L/2 mtgs by 37 & 48. Duke is 2-6 SU/ATS. Duke is off a heartbreaking loss to NCar where they led 35-31 and had a game clinching td called back then missed a fg before letting NC drive 74 yds for the GW td with :16 left. A week after throwing for 496 vs NCar, QB Van Dyke threw for another 351 and led Miami to a 20-14 (-8) despite missing 5 starters. The 'Canes led 20-0 4Q and finished w/a 458-257 yd edge. UM is +102 ypg at home while Duke is -83 ypg on the road. The Blue Devils D is allowing foes to put up 29 ypg more than their avg (#104 in FBS). Duke is rushing for 206 ypg (5.5) but UM is holding foes to just 97 (3.0) and they haven't allowed any team to hit 4.0 ypc. Duke is just 1-10 ATS on the road and if Miami gets healthier they could use this game to build confidence toward a late ssn run at the Coastal.

RUTGERS by 3 over Indiana - IND had won 5 straight in the series, prior to Rutgers pulling the 38-3 (+7) upset on the road LY. IU has played 7 str wks, while RUT is coming off a bye. Last time out RUT fell 14-13 (+3) at home to NEB, despite leading 13-0 at HT & outg'g the Huskers 348-304 for the gm. The extra rest should allow RUT to clarify the QB position, as they've already had 3 different starters TY. QB Vedral (5th yr) has started the L/2, but has been limited throwing with a hand inj. The RUT Def has been solid all'g just 314 ypg to FBS foes. IND has lost 4 str (2-2 ATS), after their 38-33 (+11') home loss to MARY, in which they were outg'd 442-351. The Hoosiers are all'g 37 ppg the L/4, while being outg'd by an avg of 120 ypg. IND has yet to cover on the road (0-2), but the Scarlet Knights have lost 21 straight conf home gms, but we like them to break that streak here. OHIO ST by 24 over lowa - 1st mtg s/117, when lowa blew the doors off the #3 ranked OSU 55-24 (+18') in Iowa City. Prior to that loss, OSU had won 5 str in the series. Both tms come in off a bye. lowa is 3-3 SU/ATS & have lost 2 str. Their offense is dead last in FBS (#131) at 239 ypg, #127 avg lowa is 3-3 SU/ATS & nave lost 2 str. Their offense is dead last in FBS (#131) at 239 ypg, #12/ avg just 15 ppg (#127) & have all'd 15 sks the L/4 wks. Their Def remains formidable all'g just 10 pts (#3) & 265 ypg (#9). Ohio St comes in at 6-0 (3-3 ATS) & is one of 2 tms to avg 300 pass & 200 rush ypg. QB Stroud is currently the Heisman fav, hitting 71% on the yr with a 24-3 ratio, w/o his top weapon Smith-Njigba who has barely plyd due to inj, but should return here. The Buckeyes D cannot be overlooked as they are all'g 16 ppg & just 254 ypg (#7). IThe Buckeyes have not lost a B10 HG s/*15 (27 st wins), but lowa is 4-2-1 as an AD s/*18 & is 3-0-1 ATS in this series, so we like the Hawkeyes to cover the large line as Ohio St has Penn St on deck & may look to rest some starters in the 2H. WAKE FOREST by 23 over Boston College - The visitor in this series is 7-0 SU/5-2 ATS but BC is a near 3 td dog. WF has won 3 of the L/4 meetings including LY's reg ssn finale, 41-10 (-5'). QB Jurkovec played hurt in that game and threw for just 19 yards. He is healthy TY and completing 61% w/a 10-6 ratio and throwing to the ACC's leading WR, Zay Flowers (556, 13.2). Both tms enter fresh off a bye, WF is 5-1/ATS on the season and are +55 ypg. QB Hartman has a 16-2 ratio and their offense puts up 51 ypg more than their foes allow. BC is just 2-4 SU/1-5 ATS and are -65 ypg but the Eagles D has been solid, holding foes 29 ypg below their avg. BC has a 30 pt loss to FSU and a 28 pt loss to Clem while WF beat FSU by 10 & lost to Clem by 6 in OT. WF is 4-0 ATS off a bye so we give them a slight lean and the Under has cashed in 10 of the last 11 mtgs (avg 41 ppg).

Pittsburgh by 3 over LOUISVILLE - Pitt is 6-1-1 ATS in this series and has won 6 of the L/7 SU.

Both tms enter fresh off a bye after winning the previous week despite significant injuries. UL was w/o QB Cunningham and beat UVA 34-17 (PK) while Pitt was w/o 2 starting OL and their top 2 WR's but still beat VTech 45-29 (-14'). RB Abanikanda has 830 (6.4) and broke Tony Dorsett's single gm school record with 320 yds vs the Hokies. UL has allowed just 98 rush (2.7) in their F/4 but did give up over 200 in each of their F/2 gms. Pitt is on a 7-0 SU/ATS run in road games and this is their ACC road opener while UL is only 5-6 SU at home the last 3 years. QB Cunningham may return this week for UL but they last time he faced Pitt he barely survived, taking 7 sacks and getting hit repeatedly. Ucf by 3 over EAST CAROLINA - UCF has won 8 of the L/9 in the series, but ECU has covered 3 str, incl in a 20-16 (+10) loss at UCF LY. This is a "Blackout" gm for the Pirates, who come in at 4-3 SU/ATS, but already have 2 AAC losses. ECU is off a 47-45 (-5) 4 OT win over MEM, in which they were actually outg'd 491-473 & are now avg'g 475 ypg. UCF has won 4 str (3-1 ATS) after their dominant 70-13 (-23') win over Temple last Thu. The Knights only led 14-13 mid 2Q, but rattled off 56 unanswered as they outg'd Temple 737-293, with 304 rush & 433 pass yds. UCF is now avg 260 rush ypg. QB Plumlee continues to improve & has thrown for 689 yds (75%) with 6-0 ratio the L/2W & is also the tms leading rusher with 455 yds (5.3) & 7 TDs. UCF HC Malzhan is 16-9-1 as an AF, but we like the Pirates to keep this one within a FG

Byu by 6 over LIBERTY - BYU won only prior mtg 31-24 in '19 as a 17 pt HF as tms comb'd for 902 yds. LU become bowl eligible LW, but needed to come from behind for a 21-20 win over Gardner-Webb being outgained 325-315. BYU trailed 31-21 at HT got to within 3 pts but fell behind Ark and lost 52-35 & BYŬ was outgained 644-471. While both have dealt with injuries Liberty has had 4 diff QB's take snaps TY & only once did QB play entire game. Both LU's #1 (OFY) & #2 (surgery) QB's are out here but QB is one position BYU has stayed healthy as QB Hall is avg 273 pg (68%, 102 rush, 17-3). BYU is not bowl eligible & will look past no one. Despite being just 4-3, BYU has the edge on Def & a bigger one on OFF (#28-#26) and has played a much tougher schedule (#19-#124). Houston by 3 over NAVY - HOU has won the L/2 vs Navy, but the Middles have covered 2 of 3. The Cougars limited the Navy option attack to 190 yds (3.7) in LY's 28-20 (-19) home win. HOU is off a bye & is carrying momentum from a 33-32 (+2') comeback win over MEM 2 wks ago. The Cougars trailed 26-7 early 4Q, but got 2 TDs in the final 1:17 (with the help of an onside kick) to come away with the win. HOU is now 3-3 (2-4 ATS) with 5 of their 6 gms decided by 7 pts or less. Navy is off a 40-34 (+12') loss to SMU, but got the backdoor cover with 9 secs left & is on a 4-0 ATS run. Despite the loss, Navy rushed for 372 yds (4.8) & have generated 414 rush ypg the L/2 wks, after avg 176 ypg their 1st 4. The road tm has won 3 of 4 in series, so we like the HOU to come away with a narrow win. Toledo by 3 over BUFFALO - Toledo is just 4-3 SU & 2-5 ATS vs Buffalo in MAC play. Last met in '19 when UB won 49-30 as an 8' pt HF but UT trailed just 28-23 late 3Q before allowing 21 straight pts. Both come in 3-0 in MAC play & leading their division. UT is 5-2 SU & 4-3 ATS but has won & covered 3 straight. UB is 4-3 SU but 6-1 ATS winning 4 straight & covering 5 straight. LW UT as a 7' pt HF trailed Kent St 21-0 1Q but only trailed 31-28 at HT & outscored KSU 24-0 in 2H finishing with a 490-393 edge. Buffalo (-17) led at UMass 24-7 at HT & won 34-7. While UT has the edge on both Off (#72-#88) & Def (#60-#79). Still these teams are very close as in MAC play UT has outperformed foes by 20 ppg & 62 ypg, while UB has outperformed foes by 19 ppg & 59 ypg. While UT is a little better we will take the Bulls getting over a TD at home here.

huge offensive edge (#43-#121) and will take out their frustrations on their rival

MIAMI, OH by 13 over Western Michigan - WM is 7-2 SU but just 4-5 ATS in series since '01. Last met in '19 when WM scored the L/17 for a 38-16 win as a 13 pt HF. Since losing QB Gabbert for the ssn in the opener Miami has alternated wins & losses incl upsetting Northwestern & LY's MAC East champ Kent St but LW could not hold onto a 13-7 lead losing to BG 17-13 as a 7 pt AD. WM has also struggled going 2-5 SU/ATS incl 2 straight MAC losses to EM & Ohio being outscored by a combined 78-37. LW WM (E) had an offensive meltdown, while they were only outgained by Ohio 383-333 the had 6 TO's incl 5 int's. Despite the struggles WM still has a slight offensive edge here (#115-#122) but Miami has a much better defense (#57-#109). Northern Illinois by 4 over OHIO - NIU has won L/2 mtg incl a 39-36 win in '19 as a 6 pt AD. Ohio is 4-3 SU & ATS and is a 4Q meltdown against Kent St leading to an OT loss away from being tied for the lead in MAC East (2-1, #2). LW they only had a 383-333 yd edge at WM but won 33-14 (E) despite settling for 4 fg's but their defense stepped up with 5 int's that stopped WM drives. LY's MAC Champion Huskies are just 2-5 SU & 3-4 ATS. LW with their backs to the wall & without QB Hampton (inj), who started the L/3, the entire team stepped up & while QB Lynch started (38 rush , 8 pass), starting QB Lombardi returned (11-15-115) after missing 3 gms with injury. The Def held EM to just 226 yds with 5 sks & the first def score of ssn (IR td). NIU has the edges on both Off (#67-#92) & Def (#89-#124) and with the return of leader Lombardi look for NIU to get the win.

JAMES MADISON by 13 over Marshall - Only 2 previous mtgs were as FCS foes in the playoffs in '87 & '94, both wins by the Herd. JMU suffered their 1st loss LW at GSthrn 45-38 while Marshall comes in with the rest edge after a 23-13 home loss to LA last Wed where they were -62 yds & -2 TO's. JMU's D was stellar up until last week as they allowed GSthrn to gain 590 yds! JMU is still holding their foes to 115 ypg under their ssn avg (#7 FBS) and overall are all'g just 290 ypg. MU RB Laborn has topped 100 yds in all 6 gms TY (846, 5.4, 10 td) but JMU's run D is giving up just 37 ypg (1.4) & MU's pass attack is avg just 189 ypg. JMU's D has also collected 18 sks (9%) and MU's OL has given up 22 sks (13.3%) this ssn. JMÜ's offense led by QB Cenetio (1775, 64%, 17-4, 306 rush, 5.0 ypc) is putting up 151 ypg above what their foes allow (#4 FBS). With Colorado failing to cover all but 1 game in '22 and being outscored by 32 ppg on the road (-296 ypg), we're backing the Beavers here as they're on an impressive 9-1 ATS run as home chalk.

UNLV where they ran for 406 (5.3). Boise St is fresh off a bye week & had extra time to prep for where they fail to 400 (3.5). Bolse St is less in a sye week a flad extra line to ple for the option. While facing the option is a tough task, the Boise run D has allowed just 101 ypg (2.9 ypc) and overall are holding foes to 102 ypg under their ssn avg (#13 FBS). Boise's offense turned a corner in their last couple gms as they topped 440 yds vs SDSt and Fresno incl rushing for 316 (7.2) vs SDSt and 316 (6.1) vs Fresno. AF has been dealing with several inj's to starters but appear to be getting healthier, however this is their 8th straight gm and Boise is 3-0 ATS since 2017 as a MW underdog & we think they get revenge and pull off the outright upset.

Rice by 6 over LOUISIANA TECH - LT had won 6 straight ssn meetings until LY when Rice pulled a 35-31 (+4) home upset. The Owls have covered the last 3 meetings. Rice has covered 4 straight, al as underdogs after only losing 17-14 (+4) last week at FAU. The Owls are +6 ypg and their D is allowing 346 ypg and holding foes 62 ypg below their avg (#31 in FBS). LT was off a win last week but gave up 475 rush yds (10.1 ypc!) and was outgained 671-504 at NT in a 47-27 (+7). The Bulldogs ăre -96 ypg and théir D`is allowing 124 ypg more than their foes avg (#129 in FBS) and they give up 263 rush ypg (6.4). Rice has the big edge on D, and a win here with home games vs CLT and UTEP on deck give the Owls a chance to reach a bowl for the first time under Bloomgren so we are taking the motivated road favorite who is battle tested with 2 close road losses to win.

STANFORD by 7 over Arizona St - Following a surprising win LW in South Bend where they ended an 11-gm losing streak against FBS foes (SU 385-301 yd edge), the Cardinal return home to take on a well-rested (off a bye) and confident Sun Devils squad that picked up a 45-38 (+13') upset against the Huskies 2 wks ago in the desert. While Stanford has won 6 of the last 8 (4-4 ATS) against ASU, they did suffer a 28-10 (+13) defeat LW in Tempe (QB McKee 3 int's). After nearly picking up their 1st P12 win in 10 tries a few wks back against the Beavers (OSU GW 56-yd TD pass w/:13 left), the Cardinal end the P12 victory drought in this one (ASU has lost their L/3 AG's by 16 ppg).

Washington by 1 over CÁLIFOŘNIA - The Bears dropped a surprising road matchup LW in OT against the winless Buffs. The Huskies meanwhile ended a 2-game losing skid LW at home against Arizona with QB Penix throwing for a school-record 516 yds and 4 TD's. Cal has dropped 9 of the L/12 in this series (split L/6) including a 31-24 (+7') OT defeat LY in the Pacific NW (Bears 2 TD's in final 5:09 to force the extra frame, fmbl at GL in OT). Over the past 2 ssns the Huskies have failed to cover 4 straight as away chalk while also losing 3 of them SU. With an angry Cal sqaud going 8-4 ATS in recent P12 contests coming in, we'll take the points in this one.

OREGON by 10 over Ucla - A pair of well-rested squads face off in Autzen Stadium with Chip Kelly (HC at UO from '09-'12) taking on his old team. The Ducks have picked up 5 straight victories (4-1 ATS) since their opening ssn loss to Georgia with a 25 pt avg MOV. The Bruins meanwhile are sitting at 6-0 (4-2 ATS) with a pair of outright home upsets prior to their bye against the Huskies (+3) and Utes (+3). Oregon has dominated the recent series against UCLA with victories in 9 of the L/10 (6-4 ATS) including LY where they overcame an early 14-0 deficit in a 34-31 win (+1). While UCLA is a solid 4-1 ATS as an AD the L3Y (incl 3 outright wins!), potential rainy conditions could cause some problems for their finesse offense in Eugene (UO outgaining home foes by 224 ypg in '22). UTSA by 6 over North Texas - The home tm is 7-1 SU/8-0 ATS in series. Last year NT was a 10

pt dog against #15 UTSA. The Roadrunners had the CUSA Title on deck and pulled QB Harris and other starters in the 2Q. NT took advantage and won 45-23. Both tms are 3-0 in CUSA play. UTSA has won 4 straight but have been battling injs all ssn and only beat FIU 30-10 as 33' pt chalk LW. NT scored to make it 14-3 late 1Q and led by at least 7 the rest of the game before pulling away for a 47-27 (-7) win vs LT. NT rushed for 475 (10.1 ypc!) with RB's Adeyi and Adaway both topping 100 yards. This is an even matchup with two explosive offenses and struggling defenses. NT comes in full of confidence and are on a 9-2 ATS run vs CUSA foes so we call for the Mean Green to stay within a td. OKLAHOMA ST by 1 over Texas - In the L/7 mtgs OSU is 5-2 SU/4-2-1 ATS against Texas. OSU comes in off a loss to TCU 43-40 in 2 OT while Texas held on to beat ISU 24-21 & the Cyclones (+16) delivered an Underdog POW winner for us on these pages. OSU's offense got out to a fast start as they led TCU 24-7 2Q but were held to just 6 pts 2H while Texas was held to 363 yds by ISU. OSU's biggest issue is their DEF, as they are all'g 498 ypg/33 ppg vs B12 foes while the Texas DEF is holding teams to 118 ypg under their ssn avg. Veteran OSU QB Sanders has played well this season (1639, 13-3, 279 rush, 8 td) & Texas has all'd over 250 pass yds to TTech, WVU and Iowa St. OSU comes in 9-2 ATS as a B12 underdog since 2018 and are 6-2 ATS the L2Y against ranked foes. Off a loss Gundy is 14-5-1 ATS since '16 & we think OSU rebounds with a upset win at home. ALABAMA by 28 over Mississippi St- Bama is 14-0 SU/10-4 ATS vs Miss St. Last year the Bulldogs settled for fg's in the 1H and trailed 21-6 despite yds being even. Bama rolled in the 2H and won 49-9. The Tide enter off a rare reg ssn SU loss after losing at Tenn 52-49 (-9). QB Young returned from injury and threw for 455 yds against a depleted Vols secondary that was missing 3 starters. Miss St fell flat last week, losing at KY 27-17 (-3') and the Bulldogs were outgained 478-225. The last time the Tide were off a regular season loss was in '19 after losing to LSU and they crushed the Bulldogs the following week 38-7 (-18'). MSU has scored just 1 fg in the last 3 trips to Tuscaloosa and have topped 10 pts just once in the last 7 trips. Bama is angry off a loss but still controls their own destiny in the SEC so we expect an A+ performance and the Tide are 13-4 as HF.

Mississippi by 3 over LSU - LSU had won 5 straight from '16-'20 but Ole Miss was 8 pt home chalk LY and led 31-7 before LSU added two late scores for a 14 pt Rebels win. The home team is 7-2 SU/8-1 ATS. Ole Miss is 7-0 but have failed to cover 3 of their L/4 including LW when the Rebels jumped to a 21-0 2Q lead over Aub but only led 41-34 4Q before adding a td. The Rebels ran for 448 was with PB's ludging and Evens along with OR Dart all tenering 410 wds 1.5 Lie off a 45 36 win over yds with RB's Judkins and Evans along with QB Dart all topping 100 yds. LSU is off a 45-35 win over Florida where QB Daniels threw for a ssn high 349 yds. LSU has ply'd a much tougher sked (#43 vs #94). Their run D will be tested after giving up 263 vs Tenn and 210 vs FL while Ole Miss' is the #3 rush offense in the FBS, avg 271 ypg (5.8). Ole Miss has 19 sks on the ssn and face a banged up LSU Oline that has allowed 22 (8.8%). We like the Rebels to pull this out by a fg.

BAYLOR by 14 over Kansas - BU comes into this mtg on a 10-0 SU/ATS run vs KU. BU is off a Thur

night loss at WVU (+90 yds, but -2 TO's) where they also lost QB Shapen (head inj, check status). KU is also off a B12 road loss where they fell 52-42 at Oklahoma & allowed 701 yds! The starter for BU if Shapen is out will be Kyron Drones, who was 7-14 and had a td pass, but also threw a costly int. Drones still may find success as the KU pass D ranks #101 & they all'd 403 yds las week. BU went into the WVU gm all'g just 320 ypg, but all'd 500 yds incl 217 rush (5.9) and KU did put up 430 yds LW and bkp QB Bean had a 4-2 ratio, but Bean is not the QB Daniels is. While BU could be w/o QB Shapen, Drones is a capable QB and KU has played several big gms in a row & could start to show signs of fatigue. We'll take the stronger team at home by 2 td's & BU is 7-3 ATS as a HF under Aranda. TEXAS TECH by 7 over West Virginia - TT has won and covered the L/3 mtgs incl pulling outright upsets the L/2 mtgs. WVU is off a home upset against BU 43-40 where they were -90 yds but forced

REVENGE PLAY OF THE WEEK......OREGON ST TE<u>CHNICAL PLAY OF THE WEEK......</u> TULANE

3 TO's while TT is off a bye week. TT should have a big edge here with their passing game as they are avg'g 365 ypg (65%) and 3rd string QB Morton threw for 379 yds (62%) against Okla St 2 wks ago as QB's Shough and Smith were out with inj. The WVU pass D ranks #114 as they have all'd their L/2 B12 foes (Texas, Baylor) to throw for over 330 yds and have been dealing with some inj's in the secondary. The WVU offense should get their points as their offense is avg'g 461 yds/39 pts per gm & the TT defense is allowing 440 ypg/37 ppg against B12 foes. With a week off to prep we think TT's strong pass attack will lead them to a win here no matter who is at QB.

TULANE by 14 over Memphis - These tms have met every yr since 2014 & the home tm has won 5 straight (4-1 ATS). MEM won 33-28 (-6) LY, despite being outg'd 452-392. MEM is off a 47-45 (+5') 4 OT loss at ECU. They have now lost 2 str after a 4 gm win streak. MEM is gaining 27 more ypg than their opps allow (#58), but is surrendering 19 yds more than their opps gain (#91). TUL won 45-31 (-12) at USF LW, which moved them to 6-1 SU/6-1 ATS. The Green Wave is #11 in scoring D at 16 ppg & #17 in ttl Def all'g just 299 ypg. The Green Wave are 12-3 as a HF since 2019 & we like them by 2 TDs over a MEM team that is 2-9 ATS on the road.

MISSOURI by 11 over Vanderbilt - MO has won the last two mtgs but Vandy has covered 3 of the L/4 including LY. The 'Dores were +16' and led 14-10 2Q. They were within 2 when MO added a 75 yd/2 play td drive late 4Q. Vandy had played 3 SEC games vs Bama/Ole Miss/UGA, losing all 3 by a combined 44 ppg but did lead Ole Miss at half. MO has lost their L/3 but enter fresh off a bye and did lead UGA 22-19 40. The Tigers are +45 ypg and they have a huge edge on D, holding foes 110 ygg below their avg while Vandy is allowing 48 ypg more than their foes avg. QB Cook only has a 5-6 ratio this year but should get a boost against a Vandy D that is allowing 67% and 333 pass ypg (#128 pass D). We think the Tigers win by double-digits but their 1-5 HF record has us cutting our lean off at 11.

Southern Miss by 1 over TEXAS ST - The last mtg came in '15 in San Marcos where SMiss won an offensive battle 56-50. SMiss is off a 20-19 win at home vs Ark St while TXSt was outgained 406-293 at Troy, but only lost 17-14 and helped cash a 4.5★ Totals GOM Winner for us! SMiss only avg 335 ypg bút their D has played better of late, all'g just 327 ypg the L/4 gms and the SMiss pass rush has 22 sks on the ssn (11.5%). SMiss has also all'd just 76 rush ypg (2.3) in SBC play and TXSt has only ran for 82 ypg (2.7) in SBC play. The TXSt OL has all'd multiple sks in all but 1 game, but held Troy w/o a sack LW. Their lone common SBC foe was Troy and SMiss was held to 205 yds & 10 pts on the road while TXSt only lost by 3 pts. While we like SMiss to win a close contest here, TXSt is on a 7-1-1 ATS run as a HD incl an outright upset of App St two wks ago.

MARYLAND by 14 over Northwestern - NW has won both previous mtgs in B10 play, incl a 43-3 (-11') home win back in 2020. NW lost 5 str (1-4 ATS) after a ssn opening win over NEB in Dublin, despité outg'g their opps in 3 of those 5 losses, but aré off a bye. QB Hilinksi started the 1st 6 gms, but bkp Sullivan did see reps in their 42-7 (+10) home loss to WISC last time out & HC Fitzgerald hinted that a QB change is possible. NW's Def is all'g 176 rush ypg & come in at #115 in our Pass D rankings. Maryland is off a 38-33 (-11') road win at IND. The Terps outg'd the Hoosiers 442-351 to move to 5-2 (4-3 ATS). MARY is avg g 460 ypg, led by QB Tagavailoa with 2001 yds (73%) w/a 13-5 ratio, but did injure his knee LW & may miss here (check status). The Terps D has shown improvement the L/3, all'g 348 ypg after all'g 410 the 1st 4 gms. MD has struggled against B10 West foes, going just 1-7 SU (0-8 ATS), but NW is just 1-4 as an AD since last ssn, so we see this one right near the line. CHARLOTTE by 13 over Fiu - CLT is just 1-5 SU in this series but did win a shootout LY 45-33 (-3'). FIU only lost 30-10 (+33') last Fri vs a banged up UTSA squad. CLT led UAB 14-10 at half but lost 34-20 (+23'). The 49ers do have veteran QB Reynolds who has a 14-6 ratio and threw for 335 and 4 td's two weeks ago against UTEP. FIU has been missing QB Gunnar Holmberg since the opener and bkp Grayson James has just a 7-5 ratio and 0-3 in the last 2 gms. FIU is still on a 3-16-1 ATS run while CLT is on a 3-10 ATS run. Both teams have bad defenses but we will side with the home 49ers who have a much stronger QB and they've played a much tougher sked (#50 vs #131). WISCONSIN by 9 over Purdue - WISC has won 12 of 15 in the series, but PUR has covered the last 3 in Madison. Both tms have a bye on deck. LY the Badgers held PUR to just 206 ttl yds in a 30-13 (-3') road win. The Badgers are 1-1 SU/ATS since firing HC Chryst, after their 34-28 (-7') 2 OT loss at Mich St, in which they were held to just 283 ttl yds. The Off is avg 35 ppg the L/2 wks, after avg 16 ppg in their 1st two B10 gms. After all'g a ssn high 539 yds to Ohio St, the Badgers Def has held the ppg in their 1st two B io gims. After all g a ssn high 339 yos to Onio St, the Badgers Der has neid the L/3 opps to 345 ypg. PUR enters with a 4 gm win streak (3-1 ATS) after their 43-37 (-14) home win over NEB (3★ LPS Winner!) as they outg'd the Huskers 608-476. The Boilers Def continued to be stout against the run with the #17 rush D all'g 100 ypg, incl just 80 ypg their L/3. Both tms enter with their B10 West title hopes still alive, but we'll roll with the Badgers & their improved Off in this one.

PENN ST by 3 over Minnesota - 1st mtg since 2019. "White Out" game for Penn St. The Nittany Lions come in off a 41-17 (+7) loss at MICH in which they were dominated on both great soft scrimmage.

PSU only trailed 16-14 at HT, despite being outg'd 274-83 with an 18-1 first down deficit. The PSU Def all'd 418 rush yds, after all'g just 81 ypg their 1st 5 gms. MINN is off a 26-14 (-4') loss at ILL, which wasn't that close as MIN was outg'd 472-180! RB Ibrahim did rush for 129 yds & is now #4 in NCAA with 139 rush ypg. Despite the loss, the Gophers Def is still #4 in scoring D, all'g just 12 ppg & #6 in ttl D at 264 ypg (#). PSU HC Franklin is just 8-23 ATS off a SU loss at Penn St & the Lions have Ohio St looming next wk, while MIN is 4-1 ATS as an AD the L2Y, so we'll take the Gophers with the points. LOUISIANA by 14 over Arkansas St - While LA is 5-1 SU vs Ark St the L/6 gms, they are just 3-3 ATS and have failed to cover the L/2 mtgs. The Cajuns picked up a big road win at Marshall last Wed 23-13 (+62 yds, +2 TO) while Ark St gave up the go-ahead TD late 4Q and lost to SMiss 20-19. While LA's offense has taken a step back TY (329 ypg/25 ppg) they are holding SBC foes to 61 ypg under their ssn avg & are +10 TO's on the season! The LA pass DEF has 11 int's on the ssn by 10 diff players & come into this gm with thr #18 pass D. LA also had 5 sks vs Marshall & now face a Ark St OL that has allowed 20 sks the L/4 gms! The Ark St offense hasn't been anything great as they are getting held to 50 ypg less than their foes allow (#107 FBS) & are -65 ypg vs SBC foes. Ark St is 4-0 ATS on the road TY, but we think the Cajuns are starting to build momentum & have the matchup edge here.

4★ Tampa Bay over CAROLINA - The Panthers return to Charlotte following a rough defeat out West against the Rams in the debut of Steve Wilks as interim HC (LAR 22-8) FD & 360-203 yd edge). The Bucs are on the road for a 2nd straight week after a shocking loss in PIT as nearly a DD favorite. The Bucs have dominated this series over the last 2 years with a perfect 4-0 SU & ATS and a 22 pt avg MOV. With CAR failing to cover 12 of their L/13 coming in and going 3-10-1 ATS as a HD and the Bucs off of a surprising defeat, we're expecting TB's recent success to continue in this one (Bucs 8-3 ATS off a SU loss L2Y w/Brady). FORECAST: Tampa Bay by 20

3★ Ny Giants over JACKSONVILLE - Following their only HG in a 4-wk span against the Ravens LW, where they moved to a surprising 5-1 with a 24-20 comeback victory (BAL 406-238 yd edge), the Giants head South to take on a Jags squad that dropped a 34-27 contest against DIV rival IND (Colts GW 32 yd TD pass w/:17 left). Although the Giants have dropped their past 2 meetings against JAX including a 20-15 home defeat in '18, the Jags have failed to cover 6 of their past 8 contests prior to their annual trip to London while also going a dismal 4-31 ATS in matchups with the NFC. FORECAST: Ny Giants by 6 OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Ny Jets over DENVER - Following their 3rd outright road upset of the ssn LW in Lambeau, where they held the Packers to just 10 pts and 278 yds, the Jets are back on the road for a 2nd straight week to take on a Broncos squad on short rest after a MNF road trip to take on the Chargers. The Broncos have been victorious in 5 of the past 6 meetings with the Jets including a 26-0 (-10) win LY where they allowed just 11 FD's and 162 yards. They are however just 3-7 ATS as home chalk including an outright defeat against the Colts a few weeks back. With DEN failing to cover 7 of their past 9 overall as of presstime and the Jets 5-1 ATS away from home, we expect the visitor to pull off another upset. FORECAST: Ny Jets by 6 OTHER PLAYS

New Orleans at ARIZONA - Thursday - The Cardinals suffered a 19-9 loss LW in SEA despite a solid day from Kyler Murray (222 pass & 100 rush yds). The Saints (9-2 ATS as an AD) meanwhile are playing their only road contest in a 5-wk span following a narrow defeat to the Bengals LW in the Superdome (NO 399-348 yd edge, led 26-21 in 4Q). In their most recent matchup inside of the Superdome in '19, the Saints (-12) picked up a 31-9 victory holding Kyler Murray and the ARZ offense to just 10 FD's and 237 yards. While the Cardinals have gone an outstanding 10-2 ATS on the road, keep in mind that they're just 3-9 ATS in the desert coming in. We'll have one of our Marquee selections

available after Noon EST on gameday.

DALLAS by 4 over Detroit - The Lions return to action following a much-needed bye as they suffered a 29-0 loss against the Patriots the week prior (led the NFL in scoring heading into Foxboro!). The Cowboys dropped their 1st contest with Cooper Rush under center (was 4-0 SU/ATS) LW against the Eagles despite a 315-268 yd edge (-3 TO's). The Lions have lost 4 consecutive meetings with the Cowboys (9 pt avg MOV) including a 35-27 home loss in '19 where they had FD (26-19) and yardage (509-312) deficits. It appears that Prescott will return under center this weekend as DAL has covered 6 of their L/9 as home chalk coming in. Despite that impressive mark, it's also worth mentioning that the Lions are an outstanding 9-1 ATS following a bye.

TENNESSEE by 7 over Indianapolis - The Colts and Titans square off for the 2nd time in October with TEN picking up a 24-17 (+3') road victory in their 1st meeting thanks in part to a +3 TO edge (IND 365-243 yd edge). The Titans get the advantage of an early bye week coming in while the Colts picked up a 7 pt home win LW against the Jags with Matt Ryan throwing for 389 yds and 3 TD's. IND has dropped 4 in a row SU and ATS against TEN being outscored by 10 ppg in the process. With the Titans also an outstanding 5-0-1 ATS after a bye and the Colts failing to cover 13 of their L/18 inside of the AFC South, the home team gets the TD edge in this one.

CINCINNATI by 3 over Atlanta - The Falcons saw their perfect ATS streak continue LW at home against the 49ers thanks to a 3-0 TO edge (SF 346-289 yd edge). They now head back on the road to take on a Bengals squad that got a GW 60-yd TD pass with 1:57 left LW in the Superdome with QB Burrow throwing for 300 yds and 3 TD's. The Bengals have picked up wins in their past 2 meetings with the Falcons including a 37-36 victory back in '18 where they threw a GW 13-yd TD pass w/:07 remaining. While CIN is on a 7-2-1 overall ATS run, keep in mind that ATL has gone 9-2 ATS against AFC foes coming in which includes an outright upset in CLE back in Wk 4.

BALTIMORE by 3 over Cleveland - Following a 23 pt home loss to the Patriots where we picked up a 3★ LP Winner (CLE 4 TO's), the Browns head into BAL to take on a Ravens squad that suffered a 4 pt road loss LW against the Giants despite a 406-238 yd edge (QB Jackson int & fmbl on L/2 drives). In their final meeting a year ago in CLE, the Browns (-3) picked up a narrow 24-22 victory to end a 4-game losing skid to the Ravens (BAL 389-290 yd edge). Although CLE is just 2-12-1 ATS in overall AFC North matchups, we're cutting off our lean at a FG for the Ravens who have gone just 2-6 as home chalk while failing to cover 5 of their past 7 inside the DIV.

Green Bay by 10 over WASHINGTON - After a disastrous trip to London where they blew a DD lead to the Giants, the Packers may have had an even uglier performance LW in Lambeau against the Jets as a 7' pt favorite (GB held to just 10 pts & 278 yds in a 17 pt defeat). The Commanders meanwhile are at home on extra rest following a narrow 12-7 win last Thur in CHI where they had substantial FD (20-14) and yardage (392-214) disadvantages. LY the Packers (-8) picked up a 24-10 win in Lambeau despite WAS finishing with 25-19 FD and 430-304 yard edges. While an angry Packers squad is just 1-4-1ATS as an AF coming in, Was (CS on QB Wentz-broke finger on throwing hand) has failed to cover 4 of their past 5 overall and needed some luck LW to knock off the Bears. LAS VEGAS by 3 over Houston - A pair of well-rested squads square off in "Sin City" as the Texans (upset win over JAX 2 wks ago) take on a Raiders team that's still hurting as the rexams (upset will over 37A/2 with age) talk on the rexams lead after blowing a 17-0 lead in Arrowhead on MNF back in Wk 5. While the Texams lead 6

the all-time series versus the Raiders 8-4, including a 27-24 home victory in their most recent matchup back in '19 (HOU 29-15 FD edge), they've had issues as a NDIV AD with covers in just 3 of their past 10. Fortunately for the visitor, the Raiders are also in a role that they've struggled in with just a 2-6 ATS mark as a NDIV HF.

SAN FRANCISCO by 3 over Kansas City - Rematch of SB LIV, a matchup that saw the Chiefs pick up the 31-20 victory. That win by the Chiefs was their 4th in 5 tries against the 49ers. The Chiefs do head to the Bay Area following a narrow defeat at home against the Bills where Mahomes threw a late int. The 49ers meanwhile are back at home after a rough road trip to ATL where they committed 3 TO's in a 28-14 defeat (SF 346-289 yd edge). While the Chiefs have covered 5 of their past 7 meetings against the NFC coming in, the 49ers have been just as solid in non-conf matchups with a 14-7 ATS mark. With SF also getting a few points inside of their home venue, we'll lean in their direction as they're on an impressive 11-4 ATS run as a dog.

LA CHARGERS by 3 over Seattle - Following a 10 pt home win against the Cardinals where their defense all'd just a FG, the Seahawks head South to take on their former DIV foe (SEA in AFC West from '77-'02) in the Chargers, who are at home for the 2nd straight week after a MNF meeting with the Broncos. The Chargers picked up B2B wins against the Seahawks in '14 and '18 (25-17 roard win as 1 pt dog) while also going 5-2-2 ATS against the NFC. They are however just 1-7 ATS prior to their bye, which doesn't bode well against a Seahawks squad that's covered 8 of their past 10 against the AFC. Pittsburgh at MIAMI - SNF - The Dolphins are at home for a 2nd straight week following an 8 pt defeat against the Vikings where 3rd string QB Thompson got his 1st career start (7-13-89-0-0) before also being lost with injury (Bridgewater 23-34-329-2-2). The Steelers meanwhile tasted victory for the 1st time since Wk 1 in a surprising 20-18 (+9') home upset of the Bucs (QB Trubisky 9-12-144-1-0 in relief of a concussed Pickett). In their most recent meeting back in '19, the Steelers (-14) picked up a 27-14 MNF home victory with a solid 21-16 FD and 394-230 yard edges. While PIT has also gone a solid 21-9-1 ATS when listed as a dog, keep in mind that MIA is 10-3-2 ATS as a HF and could get Tua back under center in this one. Chicago at NEW ENGLAND - MNF - Rematch of SB XX, a contest that saw the Bears pick up an easy 46-10 victory. Since that win in the "Big Game", the Bears have actually dropped 8 of the last 9 to the Patriots including a 38-31 defeat at Soldier Field in '18 (CHI 29-21 FD & 453-381 yd edges). CHI does head to Foxboro on extra rest following a 5 pt loss to WAS last Thur where they had a 392-214 yd edge (-2 TO's, stopped inside the 5-yd line on 3 separate drives!). The Patriots meanwhile picked up an easy 38-15 win (3★ Newsletter Winner!) LW in CLE with 3rd string QB Zappe throwing for 309 yds and 2 TD's (NE 4-1 TO edge).
