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KEY SELECTIONS

4★ FLORIDA over Missouri - The Gators will be out for legit revenge here after losing 45-16 (+3) in UF's first game after HC McElwain was fired. Florida's SEC East title hopes are gone after last week's loss to 36-17 (+7) vs Georgia. The Gators only trailed 23-17 4Q and were undone by 3 TO's which led to 14 UGA pts. QB Franks threw for just 105 yds but now faces Mizzou's #94 ranked pass eff D that just let KY to throw for 294 after avg just 101 pass ypg in their F/6 vs FBS foes. QB Lock struggled yet again vs a P5 bowl foe, throwing for 165 yds and no td's. Mizzou was held w/o any 2★ 1D's! He now has avg 183 ypg and has a 1-5 ratio this year vs SEC foes this ssn. MO is -107 ypg in SEC play while UF is +32 ypg. Florida has our #26 ranked pass eff D, but could be w/o CB Henderson who was inj'd vs UGA (CS). UF is 9-5 as a HF and MO is 2-6 as an AD. **FORECAST: FLORIDA by 20**

3★ Michigan St over MARYLAND - The home team has won the L/3 mtgs SU. Both enter off wins & have identical records. MSU has alternated W's & L's their L/5 gms, while MD has traded W's & L's their L/6 gms! MD avg just 177 ypg in their 3 losses to defensive minded tms Temple, Michigan & Iowa. Sparty held PU to a ssn low 339 yds LW & is #24 FBS, holding foes to 73 ypg less than their avg. QB Rocky Lombardi made his 1st start LW (Lewerke shoulder inj, CS) & threw for 318 yds (2-0 ratio). The 426 tld yds was MSU's most s/o the opener (ssn high 26 FD)! MSU has OSU on deck, but a win makes them bowl elig. MD is 3-19 ATS off a SU win. **FORECAST: Michigan St by 10**

3★ OREGON by 21 over UCLA - Following 6Y on the Ducks ch'g staff (46-7 record in 4Y as HC) and a pair of stops in the NFL as HC of the Eagles & 49ers, Chip Kelly makes his triumphant return to Eugene with his Bruins sitting at just 2-6 after their 31 pt loss to the Utes LW in Pasadena (Utah 26-17 FD & 470-291 yd edges). While the Ducks have their own meeting with Utah on deck, they are looking for some much needed revenge here after they saw their 6-game series win streak snapped LY on the road with star QB Herbert on the sideline with injury (UCLA 408-320 yd edge). LW's visit to Tucson did prove to be a disaster for Oregon as Arizona jumped out to a 23-8 HT lead in the eventual 29 pt victory (Ducks held to a ssn-low 15 pts and 270 yds). However, with Oregon angry from their trip to the desert and the Bruins dropping 10 of their L/11 P12 road trips overall by 16 ppg, we feel extremely comfortable riding with the home squad in this one as they look to get back on track. **FORECAST: OREGON by 21**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Texas A&M over AUBURN - The visitor is 6-0 SU in SEC mtgs with 4 outright upsets and the dog is on a 4-0-1 ATS run. Auburn is fresh off a bye, having put up an FBS ssn high 484 yds vs Ole Miss the week prior. A&M was held to a ssn low 293 yards in their 28-13 loss vs Miss St last week. The Aggies were down 8 pts at the MSU11 but threw an int then all'd a long td run. A&M held MSU's potent run gm to just 67 yds until the late 76 yd td run but gave up a surprising 241 pass yds. A&M holds their foes to 108 ypg below their avg (#9 in FBS) and gives up just 87 (3.3) rush ypg. Aub avg 172 (4.4) rush ypg. QB Stidham is comp'g 60% with a disappointing 8-4 ratio but A&M is only ranked #104 in our pass eff D rankings. Despite failing us last week, we feel A&M has the edge on OFF and D so we will call for the Aggies to pull the minor upset. **FORECAST: Texas A&M by 4**

2★ Louisiana (+) over TROY - LA is 4-1 SU (3-2 ATS) against Troy in the L/5 gms. Last mtg was back in '15 & Troy went up 24-0 in the 1Q and won 41-17 (448-310 yd edge) in the ssn finale. Troy's BJ Smith has kept the offense going after starting QB Barker went OFY 3 wks ago and has 4 straight gms of 100+ yds & could get another 100 yd gm here as the LA DEF is all'g 221 rush ypg this ssn. LA's offense is powered by 3 strong RB's (all scored over 400 yds & all avg over 5 ypc) incl Trey Ragas who has 734 rush yds (5.8 ypg, 6 TD) and scored the GW TD vs Ark St last week w/ 88 sec left. LA is 6-2 ATS this ssn & are avg'g 34 pts & 466 yds, while Troy is just 3-5 as a home favorite vs FBS foes & played last Tues so will be rested for this gm. Both teams faced CC earlier this ssn & Troy was able win 45-21, but LA fell 30-28 (all'd 311 rush yds). LA only lost to App St by 10 and we see them keeping this gm close. **FORECAST: Troy by 3**

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY October 31ST:

Ball St at TOLEDO - Toledo is 7-2 SU vs Ball St including 4 straight wins but 2-4 ATS the L/6. LY Ball St with a 1st time starting QB led 7-3 after 1Q but trailed 24-10 at HT in a 58-17 loss as a 25 pt HD. The Cardinals have covered 6 straight in the Glass Bowl covering LTH as a 20' pt AD (lost 37-19). The Rockets kept themselves in the MAC West race LW, when they upset WM 51-24 as a 6' pt AD. QB Guadagni was injured at the end of 1H (CS) but QB Peters, who has seen a lot of time this ssn, kept the ball moving in the 2★. Ball St was steam rolled by Ohio 52-14 as a 10 pt AD as they allowed 411 rush yds & 7.2 ypc. Both tms lost to EM T, UT 28-26 as a 1' pt AF, while Ball St lost 42-20 as a 3 pt HD but both were only outgained by 36 yds by EM. Toledo can not afford to slip up here but do have a HUGE game vs NIU on deck.

THURSDAY November 1ST:

Ohio by 8 at WESTERN MICHIGAN - Both are in the hunt for their divisional crowns & both already have 1 conf loss & can't afford another as they are both chasing tms that are undefeated in MAC play. WM is 19-5 vs Ohio s/82, incl 4 wins. They last met in the '16 MAC Championship, when an undefeated #13 WM only led 26-23 late 4Q before winning 29-23 (-17). Both tms beat BG, Ohio 49-14 as a 16' pt HF with a 597-314 yd edge, while WM only won 42-35 with just a 568-511 yd edge. These teams had very different Thursday night gms LW. WM lost QB Wassink (CS) in the 1Q & backup QB Eleby, making his first career appearance, went 23-28-293 yds with a 2-0 ratio but was sacked 5 times. WM allowed 268 rush yds (7.7 ypc) to Toledo losing 51-24 as a 6' pt HF. While Ohio ran for 411 yds (7.2 ypc) against Ball St in a 52-14 win as a 10' pt HF. We expect both rushing trends to continue here and will call for the Bobcats to get it done here.

Northern Illinois by 9 over AKRON - Last met in '13 when #23 NIU only won 27-20 as a 23' pt HF. While both are off a short week, NIU is off a long trip after playing in the altitude in Provo, Utah, while Akron is home for a 2nd straight week. NIU did have a successful trip, as they upset BYU 7-6 as a 7 pt AD. Akron almost blew a 17-0 HT lead vs CM, as after allowing a strip sack at their own 11 then fumbled the KO after a CM FG that set up a CM 7 yd td drive, they held on for a 17-10 win as a 5 pt HF with a 303-300 yd edge. NIU beat CM 24-16 as a 14 pt HF TY despite being outgained 322-284. While both offense have struggled (NIU #120, UA #121) NIU has the defensive edge (#27-#81). That and the fact that NIU has a better record against a tougher schedule (#48-#96) has us leaning with the Huskies on the road here.

UCF by 6 over Temple - The home team is on an 0-3 ATS series run. Both enter fresh off a bye & are expected to have key players ret'g from inj in UCF QB McKenzie Milton & TU RB Ryquell Armstead. While UCF is #11 FBS on OFF avg 99 ypg more than their foes allow, TU is #14 on D, all'g 99 ypg less than their foes avg. UCF all'd 274 (5.6) rush ypg vs UConn, FAU & Memphis. TU has won 5 of 6 SU w/their lone loss at BC in a gm they finished w/tds yds edge. With the Owls finding their stride after a slow start, we'll back them to keep this game closer than expected.

FRIDAY November 2ND:

VIRGINIA by 13 over Pittsburgh - The home team is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS & the chalk has gone 7-1 in this series. This game surprisingly has huge ACC Coastal implications with both coming in with 1 conf loss. Pitt ran for 484 yds incl 149 from RB Ollison in their 54-45 (+2). The Panthers 634 yds, their most s/16 but also gave up 619! UVA enters off a 10 pt win over N Carolina (-9). The 'Hoos held a 268-66 rush yd edge with QB Perkins doing most of the work with 112 yds. UVA holds their foes to 84 ypg below their foes ssn avg (#24 in FBS) and allows just 111 (3.7) rush ypg. Pitt's OFF avg 20 ypg less than what their foes allow (#91 in FBS). The 'Hoos are +121 ypg at home, covering all 4 gms while Pitt is -161 ypg on the road. Pitt is 11-5 as an AD under HC Narduzzi but UVA is on a 7-1 ATS run and we can't go against HC Mendenhall.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 14 over Wku - Wku has won 3 straight in this series and there's been 4 outright upsets in the L/6 mtgs. We picked up a 4★ winner LW on the OVER in MT's 51-17 (-4) win over ODU. The MOV was misleading as MT got a 100 yd pick-6 to finish the 1H then added another pick-6 with 1:37 left. The Blue Raiders actually finished -32 yds and -4 FD's. Wku is now 1-7, losing 38-17 (+3) vs FIU last week. Wku is -92 ypg in CUSA play while MT is -58. Both OFF's have struggled, but QB Stockstill

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is getting healthier and threw for a ssn high 280 yds last week. WKU has been solid as a dog but doesn't have much to play for while MT is still in contention in the CUSA East and has covered 6 of their L/7 as a HF. **SATURDAY November 3rd:**

Houston by 20 over SMU - It's homecoming in Dallas, but the 'Pony Express' would even have trouble keeping up with a UH OFF that is avg over 7 yds/pl! UH is on a 6-3 ATS series run. SMU enters off an emotional home loss vs Cincy where they trailed by DD's 2★ only to take the lead before all'g the gm tying 41 yd fg w/no time left. In the 1st OT Ben Hicks threw an int that was ret'd 86 yds for a td. UH delivered another top play winner on these pages LW in their 3 td win over previously undefeated USF (4★'s now 8-1 TY), finishing w/a ssn high 684 yds, despite future 1DC DL Oliver out (knee, CS). SMU is all'g 225 (4.4) rush ypg in AAC play & has our #95 PDR. UH is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks, but SMU is 7-12 as a HD.

Iowa by 7 over PURDUE - Iowa is ply'g w/legit revenge after falling at home LY 24-15 (-7) & is 8-1 ATS when averaging a SU home loss. Iowa has covered the L/4 mtgs in West Lafayette. PU off their emotional win over OSU the wk prior, had their 4 gm win streak snapped LW at MSU, getting held to ssn lows in FD's (16) & yds (339). Iowa enters off an emotional loss at PSU. Down 6 mid 4Q, Iowa's L/2 drives ended w/an int at the PSU 3 & SOD at the PSU 44. Iowa is on the 2nd of B2B away gms & travelling for the 4th time in 5 wks, but remains in contention to make the B10 Champ gm. Iowa has held 3 P5 foes to ssn lows in yds incl B2B gms & is #5 FBS holding foes to 138 ypg less than their avg. PU is off OSU & MSU in B2B wks & is 10-18 ATS at home, while Iowa is 22-10-2 away from Iowa City.

GEORGIA ST by 6 over Texas St - GST has won 3 straight SU (2-1 ATS) in this series. Last ssn this game was close the whole way (no tm led by more than 7 pts) and GST got a GW TD run w/ 6 min left 40 to win 33-30 (GST 530-390 yd edge). Both teams come into this gm struggling as TXSt is 2-6, but is off a 27-20 win at home against lowly NMST. GST is 2-6 (1 win vs FCS foe) and are off a 3rd straight SBC loss (37-34, but had 521-476 yd edge) to CC. GST's one SBC win this ssn is against ULM (46-14) and TXSt fell to ULM 2 wks ago 20-14. TXSt has struggled on offense this ssn, ranking last in the SBC in total offense, but have gotten solid play from their defense (#3 in SBC in total defense). GST ranks toward the bottom in both offense (#7) & defense (#10) in the SBC. GST QB Dan Ellington is completing 62% (1,725 yds, 9-2 ratio) of his passes this ssn & also leads the tm in rush yds (392, 5 TD) and has true dual-threat capability. TXSt has 1 SU win in SBC play s/2016, but GST is just 3-6 at home SU in the L/2Y.

Syracuse by 10 over WAKE FOREST - Last year QB Dungey was a late scratch but Cuse led 41-27 early 3Q when WF went on a 40-5 run to finish the game and broke the record for points by an opponent in the Carrier Dome with 64. The game also set an ACC record with 1,355 tll yards. HC Babers has his team bowl elig for the first time in his tenure after beating NCS1 51-41 (+2) last week. QB Dungey, who was benched the wk prior, threw for 411 yds and 3 td's. WF put up a ssn high 591 yds in a 56-35 (+2) win over LVille. RB Colburn ran for a career high 243 yds (12.1). Both tms come in with explosive OFF's. Cuse avg 561 yds and 85 ypg more than their foes allow (#16 in FBS) and WF has topped 500 yds on 4 occasions and avg 69 ypg more than their foes allow (#23 in FBS). WF is 15-8 ATS vs ACC foes and Cuse prefers the dog role so we will lean with WF.

Georgia by 14 over KENTUCKY - When the ssn started, who would have thought this game would decide the SEC East title? UGA enters off their 36-17 (-7) win over Florida where the Dawgs held the Gators to 275 yds and took advantage of 3 UF TO's which they converted to 14 pts. RB Swift looked like the back most expected him to be, going for 104 (8.7). UK trailed Mizzou 15-3 w/5 min left, but pulled out a last second win. QB Wilson threw for a ssn high 267 (prev high only 163) but RB Snell was held under 100 yds for the 3rd time in 4 gms. UGA is #19 on OFF, avg 78 ypg more than their foes allow. KY is #8 on D, allowing 120 ypg below their foes avg. KY has 22 sks this year led by OLB Josh Allen, but UGA has given up just 12. In KY's L/5 they've scored just 19 ppg and 298 ypg. UGA holds foes 71 ypg below their avg and just held UF to a ssn low 275 yds. UGA is 14-7 ATS away and from home and KY is 4-11 as a HD and UGA has a huge QB edge. **CINCINNATI by 5 over Navy** - With LY being the 1st mtg s/56 it's not hard to justify UC all'g 569 rush yds to Navy's option. UC rebounded from their 1st loss w/an emotional come-from-behind win at SMU LW. A 41 yd fg w/no time left sent the gm into OT, then on the 3rd play of OT, the 'Cats got an 86 yd IR td. Navy is on a 5 gm losing streak & hasn't lost 6 str s/11. DT Cortez Broughton anchors the UC DL that is all'g 81 (2.7) rush ypg in AAC play. This is UC's 1st HC in 4 gms, while Navy is on the 2nd of 3 str away gms. Navy is 28-12 as an AD, while UC is 4-8 as home chalk.

OHIO ST by 24 over Nebraska - Both enter fresh w/OSU off a bye & NU off an easy FCS win with the starters resting by HT. OSU is 4-0 ATS as B10 rivals & has won the L/3 SU by an avg of 42 ppg! OSU used the bye to concentrate on fixing its run gm that had an Urban Meyer era low 76 (3.0) 2 wks ago & NU is all'g 200 (5.3) rush ypg in B10 play. NU has our #61 PDR & Dwayne Haskins has thrown for 2,801 yds (71%, 30-5 ratio) vs foes w/an avg PDR of #56. This is OSU's lone home gm in a 5 wk stretch. On the road NU has lost by 46 at Michigan & 17 at UW, but interestingly vs 2 common foes (MN & PU) OSU is -7 ppg & +58 ypg while NU is +6 ppg & +126 ypg!

Georgia Tech by 1 over NORTH CAROLINA - NC is 5-15 SU in this series but GT ended a 3 gm series losing streak LY with a 26 pt victory (-9) which we used for a 3★ LPS winner. The home team is 11-4 SU/9-5-1 ATS. GT took advantage of a young VT defense last Thurs in a 49-28 (+3) win. NC has lost 4 straight incl LW, 31-21 (+9) at UVA. This is only NC's 3rd home gm and previously they beat Pitt and should have upset VT (+147 yds) while GT is +110 ypg on the road. NC QB Elliott has a 6-0 ratio in the L/4 and all 4 of his int's this year came in the opener. GT is #85 in our pass eff D rankings. The Tar Heels allow 191 (4.7) rush ypg and last year they gave up 403 (6.1) to GT's option. The Jackets are 8-2 as an AD. We will call for GT to pull the upset in what could be a high scoring affair.

MIAMI, FL by 10 over Duke - Miami has dominated this series, winning 12 of the L/13 and covering the L/4. We went against Miami last week for our 3★ Marquee GOM, picking up an easy winner with BC beating the 'Canes 27-14. HC Richt went back to QB Rosier last week and he hit just 19-36-150-1-2. Duke enters off a 54-45 (-2) loss where they led by DD's 3x in the 2★ but Pitt got the GW td w/0:05 left (safety added w/no time left). QB Jones set career highs with 396 pass yds and 4 td's but Duke's run D failed miserably, allowing 484 (9.3). RB Jackson set a school rec with 403 All-Purp yds incl 162 rush (16.2) but faces a much better Canes D that allows just 120 (3.1) rush ypg and leads the nation in tll's with 89 (14) by both DE Garvin and DT Willis). Miami allows 133 ypg below their foes avg (#6 in FBS). Duke is 3-0 as a dog this year but we will go with Miami's series dominance and call for a DD win.

NC STATE by 1 over Florida St - NCS1 is 13-3-1 in this series and the home team is 5-3 SU/6-1-1 ATS however, roles are reversed this year, with NCS1 being favored for the first time in series history! Last week QB Finley threw for a career high 473 and WR Harmon went 11-247 but fell behind 24-7 and their D gave up 561 yds in a 51-41 (-2) loss. FSU suffered their most lopsided home loss in school history vs Clemson last week 59-10 (+17) and were outgained by 277 yds. QB Francois was inj'd and didn't return (CS). NCS1's OFF avg 115 ypg more than their foes allow (#10 in FBS) while FSU's OFF is #112, avg 53 ypg less than their foes allow. NCS1 is in a rare role being fav'd in this series and don't put too much stock into LW's lopsided loss for FSU considering NCS1 also got clobbered by Clemson the week prior. We will call for FSU to keep it tight.

Memphis by 7 over EAST CAROLINA - EC had their 11 gm ATS series win streak snapped LY as the favorite is now on an 8-0 ATS run. Both enter fresh off much needed byes as EC has lost 4 of 5 incl 3 str, while UM has dropped 3 of 4 incl B2B. Despite only 2 wins SU, EC has only been out'd in 1 gm & their D is #10 FBS holding foes to 106 ypg below their avg. True frosh QB Holton Ahlers repl'd an ineffective Reid Herring 3 wks & earned his 1st start vs UCF, throwing for 406 yds. UM is #94 on D all'g 20 ypg more than their foes avg & is #101 in our PDR. RB Darrell Henderson leads the FBS avg 10.1 yds/carry, but was inj'd at Mizzou & is a ? here (CS). A long series ATS streak was snapped LY & we'll lean with the dog & call for another long ATS series streak to end TY.

Boston College by 10 over VIRGINIA TECH - VT has won the last 3 meetings, all by at least 2 scores but BC has actually covered the L/5 and is 6-3-1 ATS in Blacksburg. We picked up a 3★ winner on BC last week with the Eagles pulling yet another upset on Red Bandana day, beating Miami 27-14 (+3), also 2★ on these pages). AJ Dillon ret'd from injury and ran for 149 (4.7) against a Canes D that entered allowing just 105 rush ypg. VT is off a 21 pt loss to GT and Bud Foster's D all'd VT's most rush yds since 1973 with 465 (9.7). The Hokies allow 40 ypg more than their foes avg (#105 in FBS) and BC avg 24 ypg more than their opp's allow (#57 in FBS). BC is on a 14-3 ATS run and has covered 7 straight ACC road gms while VT is only 2-5 ATS vs ACC foes.

Oklahoma by 14 over TEXAS TECH - The home team in this series is on a 5-0 ATS run. Following their lone loss, OU has ply'd it's 2 best gms of the ssn the L2W! QB Kyler Murray (2,329, 73%, 28-3 ratio) leads an OFF that is #1 FBS avg 185 ypg more than their foes allow & enters off ssn highs 32 FD's & 702 tlk yds LW vs KSU. Since firing their DC after the RRR, OU has held their L/2 foes to 152 & 111 yds below their avgl! TT enters #9 FBS on OFF avg 119 ypg more than their foes allow, but was held to a ssn low 30 (1.3) rush LW in their emotional loss at ISU. TT has Texas on deck, while OU has Bedlam (2-4 ATS gm before) next. OU is 20-11 ATS away.

TEXAS by 9 over West Virginia - Could this be a preview of the B12 Title gm? There has been 4 outright upsets in 6 mtgs as B12 rivals. WV enters on 2 days extra rest following their 44 pt blowout over BU. Will Grier was inj'd & OFY diving for the pylon in the 1Q of LY's mtg. He's thrown for 2,272 (70%, 25-7 ratio) TY, incl compl 68% (8-2 ratio) vs KSU & TT (#28 & #21 PDR's). TX was flat 2 wks ago following their RRR win & fell compl by over 2 td's LW in Stillwater despite QB Sam Ehlinger ref'g from inj. The 'Horns have our #46 PDR. WV is 3-1 as an AD, while TX is 2-8 as home chalk. The winner will remain in control of their B12 Champ gm destiny.

WISCONSIN by 35 over Rutgers - Both mtgs have come as B10 rivals. UW is 2-0 SU/ATS, winning by an avg of 43 ppg & covering by an avg of 22 ppg! RU enters off a QB Alexed by following 7 str losses (2-5 ATS). UW has alternated wins & losses their L/4 gms. Ply'g w/o QB Nedy Hornibrook (conc, CS) & several D str's showed in LW's loss at NW. RB Jonathan Taylor's fumble issues plagued him again as well. RU is #128 FBS on OFF avg 144 ypg less than their foes allow as true frosh QB Sitkowski has a 3-15 ratio! RU is travelling for only the 2nd time in the L/7 wks, while UW is in a NW/PSU sandwich, but the Badgers have no room to look past the Knights here. RU is 0-4 as an AD, while UW is 24-12-1 ATS in B10 home gms. RU all'd 400 (8.3) rush vs KU, so how many rush yds do you think UW will end up with?

Notre Dame by 14 over NORTHWESTERN - 49th all-time mtg, but the 1st in Evanston s/76! NW pulled a major upset in the last mtg, winning 43-40 (+17) in South Bend. NW is in a B10 sandwich & still has Conf Champ Gm aspirations following their 14 pt win vs UW LW. The undefeated Irish led Navy 27-0 at HT LW & must continue to win out to make the Playoff. ND brings a balanced OFF attack led by QB Ian Book, who is 5-0 since taking over as the str 4 gms into the ssn. NW has all'd 200+ rush yds twice & is #62 in our PDR. NW is 5-1 as a non-conf home dog of 6+ points. ND is on the 2nd of B2B away gms with Fla St on deck, but is 6-3 as chalk away from South Bend.

Minnesota by 14 over ILLINOIS - MN is on a 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS series run & enters on an extra days rest following their emotional 1st conf win vs IU last Fri that saw them give up a 3 td 4Q lead before adding the 67 yd GW td pass w/1:34 left. Rfr Tanner Morgan st'd in place of inj'd Zack Annexstad (CS) & threw for 302 yds & 3 td's. IL enters having lost 5 of 6 SU incl 3 str following LW's blowout at MD where they all'd a ssn high 712 yds! IL is #129 FBS on D, all'g 161 ypg more than their foes avg. They're all'g 304 (6.7) rush ypg in B10 play & has our #113 PDR. IL is home for the lone time in a 4 wk span, but is 4-11 as a HD. MN is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks, but HC Fleck is 6-2 as away chalk. A win here will make MN 1 away from becoming bowl elig.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 14 over Central Michigan - Tms have played every year s/72. CM is 7-2 SU & 6-3 ATS in the series but the HT is 4-1 SU & has covered the L/2. LY EM trailed 28-10 late 2Q but only trailed 35-30 4Q & had the ball but threw a INT that was ret'd 33 yds for a td & a misleading 42-30 loss as a 2 pt AD. Against 4 common MAC foes CM is 0-4 SU & 1-3 ATS (-11 ppg), while EM is 1-3 SU & 2-2 ATS (+2.25 ppg). CM's only win is over an FCS tm & they have dropped 4 straight MAC gms SU & ATS. EM is 4-5 with 4 losses by 7 pt or less incl 2 in OT with a win over Purdue & they have won their L/2 MAC gms SU & ATS vs Toledo & Ball St. Both were shutout in the 1H LW and while both teams had 2★ comebacks fall short they were both very different. EM's 22 pts came off 3 drives for a combined 159 yds, while CM's 10 pts came off 2 "drives" for a combined 59 yds (off TO's). With CM out of bowl contention they began getting a lot of their younger players experience LW. EM is still in the bowl hunt and should take care of business here.

ARMY by 7 over Air Force - The C-in-C trophy is up for grabs in this game. If AF wins they win the trophy (beat Navy 35-7 earlier this ssn) & if Army wins they are guaranteed to keep the trophy. AF is 25-4 SU in this series s/1989, but 2 of those wins for Army have come s/2012 incl LY. In the gm last year Army shutout AF 21-0 w/ a 392-184 yd edge (AF held to 89 rush yds) & a 20-12 FD edge. QB Donald Hammond was dealing w/ an injury a few weeks ago, but appears to be ready to go. Even AF's bkp QB Isaiah Sanders has proven capable of running the offense effectively. AF is 9-2-1 the L/4Y as an away dog, but will be w/ 2nd leading WR Ronald Cleveland (241, 16.1, 2 TD) who is out indef w/ a leg inj, while Army is just 6-10 as a home favorite in that same span. Army had a 219-18 yd edge & 15-0 FD edge in the 1H vs EM (led 16-0). AF is off a tough MW loss to Boise (48-38, outgained 530-443) at home and will be traveling cross country to play. Army is 16-5 SU the LWY and we like them to pull out a close home victory.

USF by 3 over Tulane - TU has ply'd in Florida 4 of the L5Y & is 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS. There wasn't a more fake undefeated tm going into LW than USF & we went against them as our top play on these pages LW, easily winning our 4★ in their 21 pt loss at UH (Top college play now 8-1 TY!). USF all'd a ssn high 684 yds LW & is #112 FBS on D, all'g 55 ypg more than their foes avg. The Bulls allow 272 (5.4) rush ypg at home & TU is avg

233 (4.8) rush ypg in AAC play. LSU transfer QB Justin McMillan made his 1st car start in LW's win at Tulsa & looked comfy running the spread option attack (75, 9.4, 2 td rush). TU is on the 2nd of B2B away games, while this is the lone home game in a 4 wk stretch for USF. The Bulls did defend the option in B2B wks to open the ssn, but after having their undefeated bubble burst, we'll call for a closer than expected outcome.

App St by 14 over COASTAL CAROLINA - 5th all-time mtg, 2nd as FBS foes & App St is 4-0 SU/LY CC led App St 22-17 in the 3Q before the Mountaineers scored 3 straight TD's & recovered an onside kick after a CC 4Q TD & won 37-29. App St will be in a foul mood after getting hammered 34-14 by their rival GStm last Thurs. CC is off a 37-34 win at GSU and are just 1 win away from bowl eligibility. App St will see a potent rush offense for a 2nd gm in a row as CC avg's 253 rush ypg, and App St just all'd GSU to run for 227 LW. CC's OL has had trouble in pass pro as they have all'd 24 sks this ssn. App St QB Zac Thomas left last gm with an inj and is ? to play, which would be a tough loss after already losing str RB Jalim Moore for the ssn. App St is 7-1 SU (5-3 ATS) off of a loss the L3Y & CC is just 2-4 as DD dogs. With those inj's for App St and CC playing well, this game could be a bit closer than expected.

BOISE ST by 7 over BYU - Boise holds a 6-2 lead in this series SU, but are just 3-5 ATS against the Cougars. Boise is also 4-0 SU at home vs BYU. LTH Boise needed a 4Q TD run w/ under 11 min left to escape w/ a 28-27 win. LY Boise fell behind 7-0 but then shutout BYU the rest of the way & won 24-7 (300-238 yd edge, 19-12 FD edge). Boise is off of a hard-fought 48-38 road win at AF, which was their first ever win there. QB Rypien is back on track after a rough 2-gm stretch vs SDSU & Nev (469 yds, 2-5 ratio) and has thrown for 707 yds & a 9-0 ratio the L/2 weeks. BYU's offense is putting up just 23 ppg & 326 ypg and were held to 6 pts & 301 yds vs NIU LW. BYU will be facing a defense that allows 359 ypg this ssn & has 24 sks. Boise is also holding foes to 41 yds below their ssn avg. Boise is just 6-16 as a home favorite the L4Y while BYU is 9-3 as an away dog in that same span. These foes are familiar w/ each other & Boise has a BIG MW gm vs Fresno on deck next Friday.

San Diego St by 7 over NEW MEXICO - This series has seen both teams dominate as NM won 8 in a row from 2001-08 and SDSU has won the last 6 mtgs. SDSU has been winning w/ defense this ssn as they are all'g 307 ypg, 18 ppg and are holding teams to 84 rush ypg. Also they are holding foes to 84 ypg below their ssn avg. NM bkp QB Sherion Jones has had 3 tough weeks as he is completing 48% for 407 yds & a 3-4 ratio. NM's offense as a whole has been down the L3W as they are putting up 290 ypg & 14.6 ppg and are off a 61-19 (outgained 704-291) blowout loss at MW power Utah St. SDSU is off of a close road loss at Nevada (28-24) as their defense held the Wolf Pack to just 297 yds (-2 TO). The Aztecs are 13-5 SU & ATS in MW road games the last 5 years while NM is on a 4-11 ATS run going back to LY. SDSU keeps finding ways to win this ssn despite inj's to their top RB Washington & QB Champman, but their offense has not been impressive (21 ppg, 349 ypg) & NM should keep this gm closer than expected.

WYOMING by 7 over San Jose St - SJSU has won all 3 mtgs as MW foes (2-1 ATS). LY WY was playing w/o Josh Allen & they lost to SJSU 20-17 in the ssn finale. WY won their 1st MW gm of the ssn last Fri at Colo St 34-21 as true frosh QB Sean Chambers got his first career start & injected life into WY's offense. Chambers was 7-10 passing for 2 TD's & also ran for 176 yds & 1 TD. SJSU fell to Colo St earlier in the ssn 42-30. WY's best offensive weapon is RB Nico Evans (979 yds, 6 TD, 6.6 ypc) & faces a SJSU run D all'g 234 ypg the L/4 wks. SJSU is avg'g 307 ypg & 23 ppg against FBS foes this ssn, but are off a 50-37 win vs UNLV where they put up 506 yds. SJSU will be facing a WY defense that holds foes to 94 yds below their ssn avg. Both lost close gms to Hawaii TV as WY lost 17-13 on GW TD pass w/ 86 sec left and SJSU lost 44-41 in 5 OT. WY is 2-0 as a HF the L3Y. SJSU is just 2-11 SU in MW play the L2Y. WY will be w/o stud DT Younghana Ghaifan (34 tk, 2 sk, 6 ft) who is suspended indef.

WASHINGTON ST by 16 over California - The Golden Bears have dominated this series with an 11-2 SU mark (6-7 ATS) including a 37-3 outright upset (+16) of the #8 Cougars in Berkeley where the Cal defense forced 7 TO's. While it's no surprise that they were able to get back into the win column during their most recent road trip in Corvallis (42 pt victory, 539-241), LW's 12-10 stunner over the Huskies (+11) was one of the bigger storylines in CFB as they held a UW offense that came in avg 431 ypg to just 250! In a P12 North battle LW in Palo Alto, the Cougars rallied back from an 11 pt HT deficit to stay alive in the CFB Playoff picture (QB Minshew 40-50 for 438 yds & 3 TD). Both come into the Palouse off of big victories, we'll be counting on the Cougars to continue their impressive season here (11-0 SU run in Pullman) against a Cal team that has dropped 14 of their past 15 conf road contests.

Marshall by 8 over SOUTHERN MISS - Marshall had won 5 straight from '11-'15 but SM won the L/2 (MU 6-1 ATS series run) and the Herd is out for revenge after losing on senior day LY 28-27 (-2). Marshall enters fresh off a bye, having upset FAU the wk prior 31-7, though they were outgained by 24 yds (+5 TO's). We won a 3★ LPS going against SM last week with Charlotte pulling an outright upset. QB Abraham threw 3 int's then was inj'd in the 4Q (?), CS). Marshall could get QB Green back after missing the L/3. RB King has avg'd 162 (6.9) rush ypg the L/3. SM avg 308 pass ypg but MU is #27 in our pass eff D rankings, led by S Gant (#1 tk/r, 2 int) and CB Jackson (10 pbu). SM is +138 ypg on the ssn but has played our #126 toughest sked and Marshall is +58 ypg on the road so we will call for the Herd, who is 7-2 ATS on the road, to win by just over a td.

Georgia Southern by 3 over ULM - Have met 3 times as SBC foes, with GS winning all 3 gms SU (1-2 ATS). In their last mtg ('16) ULM jumped out to a 14-0 1Q lead before GS scored 23 straight pts to lead 23-14. ULM would score a TD w/ 10 min left 4Q to trail 23-21 but then missed a FG & fumbled on their L/2 poss and lost by 2. ULM is off a bye and had extra time to prep for the GS option & are riding a 2 gm SBC win streak. GS is off of a emotional home win vs #25 App St last Thurs, where they held them to just 288 yds & 14 pts. GS is just 2-5 as a AF the L3Y, but ULM is just 3-8-1 the L6Y as a HD. ULM has all'd foes to rush for 250+ yds 4 times this ssn & has all'd 485 ypg overall. GS is gaining 276 ypg on the ground this ssn, incl 277 yds against App St's top-rated SBC DEF. GS also ranks 2nd in total def in the SBC & is all'g just 19 ppg, 349 ypg and is holding foes to 27 yds below their ssn avg. We can't ignore the situation however, w/GS off a huge upset win with Troy on deck.

Despite their dual-threat signal caller getting closer to 100% health on a Friday night in Tucson, we're surprised AZ is favored by over a fg & we'll call for the Buffs to win the gm SU. Utah by 11 over ARIZONA ST - The Sun Devils have dominated this series with a 12-2 SU mark including a 30-10 upset win LW in SLC as a DD dog (ASU forced 4 TO's, all'd just 265 tt yds). LW they ended a 2-game losing streak against a banged up Trojans squad in LA thanks in part to another huge performance from RB Eno Benjamin (185 yds, 2 TD). Utah meanwhile earned an easy 31 pt win LW in Pasadena against the Bruins behind a big effort from their own RB in Zack Moss (211 yds, 3 TD). With the Utes cashing 4 in a row SU & ATS against P12 this month with a 24 pt avg MOV, we're calling for the visitor to claim the victory in this one.

usc by 14 over OREGON ST - While the Beavers are just 9-61-4 all-time against USC, they have actually knocked off a trio of ranked Trojan squads dating back to 2006. The past 2 years at Corvallis has been anything but positive however with the Beavers' lone victories coming against FCS members Portland St & Southern Utah. Despite those issues in front of their home fans, they were able to deliver a surprising comeback OT victory LW in Boulder (trailed 31-3) while ending their 22-game road losing streak in the process. Following a 3 pt loss at home LW against the Sun Devils with injuries plaguing them on both sides of the ball (rFr QB Sears 20-28-235-2-0 in 1st start), the Trojans (7-3 ATS as an AF) a now 2 gms behind the Utes atop the P12 South standings. While the Beavers have dropped 4 of their past 5 overall ATS coming in, recent history in Corvallis along with questions under center (starting QB Daniels? as of presstime) for the Trojans has us leaning with the home dog in this one.

WASHINGTON by 13 over Stanford - Following a 3 pt loss LW on "The Farm" against the Cougars where WSU hit the Gm 42 yd FG w/19 left to ruin Stanford QB Costello's impressive outing (34-43 for 323 yds & 4 TD), the Cardinal headed up to Seattle for a battle in the P12 North with the Huskies. This matchup has lost some of its luster however as UW also comes in following a surprising defeat in Berkeley against the Bears (Huskies held to ssn-lows with 10 pts, 13 FD's & 250 yds). LY the Cardinal erased a 14-10 HT deficit in the eventual 30-22 victory (RB Love 166 rush yds & 3 TD). While Stanford is on an 11-7 ATS run against ranked foes, we'll go ahead and call for the Huskies to get back on track in this one as the HT is on a 4-0 ATS run in the series.

Iowa St by 20 over KANSAS - KU has covered 5 of the L7 mtgs in Lawrence. ISU enters having won 4 of 5 incl 3 str following their hard fought 40-31 (-6) win vs TT. With 310lb NG Ray Lima taking up multiple blk'r's, DE JaQuan Bailey continues to rack up tt's for an ISU D that is #3 FBS, holding foes to 149 ypg less than their avg. KU was -197 yds in their 1 pt win vs TCU LW. Against 4 common foes (TCU/OSU/WV/TT) ISU is +7 ppg & +89 ypg, while KU is -17 ppg & -216 ypg! ISU is travelling for the 1st time in 4 wks, but is 6-1 ATS on the B12 road & still has B12 Champ gm aspirations. KU is 2-5 as a HD.

TENNESSEE by 28 over Charlotte - 1st mtg. Tenn will be eager to get a win after losing B2B gms incl by a fg to SC last week. Tenn led 21-9 3Q but was SOD twice in the 4Q and SC got the go-ahead fg with 5:52 left. We went with Charlotte as a 3★ LPS and picked up a winner on the improving 49ers who led 17-0 2Q and held on for the outright upset over SM 20-17 (+7). Tenn is holding their foes to 16 ypg below their avg against our #16 toughest sked. Charlotte's D has held foes to 97 ypg below their ssn avg (#17 in FBS) but they've faced our #124 toughest sked. Charlotte's OFF has been held under 300 yds on 3 occasions and QB Shirreffs who has started the L/3 for in/ld QB Reynolds (OFY) is compl'g just 54% with a 2-3 ratio. This should be an easy win for the Vols who still have bowl hopes and Charlotte is 1-6 as a dog of 20+ pts.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 14 over Louisiana Tech - Miss St has won the 3 most recent mtgs, covering the L/2. Miss St's 57-21 (-9) win LW was extremely misleading as MSU scored a ST's td, a defensive td and LT has their famed 87 yard loss from a bad snap. QB Fitzgerald had by far his best pass gm LW in MSU's 15 pt win over A&M, throwing for 241 yds & 2 td's along with 88 rush yds. LT has won 3 straight after beating FAU 21-13 (+3) last week. RB Dancy went for 116 (4.8) and DE Jaylon Ferguson broke the CUSA All-Time Sack record (38). LT has covered their L/6 on the road and earlier TY outgained LSU in a 17 pt loss. LT's rush D is a concern, having given up 200+ rush yds on 4 occasions and their OL has allowed 23 sks and may be overmatched against MSU's DL led by AA candidates DE Sweat and DT Simmons. MSU is 7-1 ATS vs non-conf foes while LT is 12-3 as an AD incl 4 straight covers.

Oklahoma St by 3 over BAYLOR - It's homecoming in Waco, but OSU is on a 9-3 ATS series run. BU enters having lost 4 of their L/6 gms SU & despite being fresh off a bye LW, was throttled at WW by 44 pts & held to a ssn low 287 yds! Charlie Brewer was repl'd 2Q after his 3rd int w/Jalan McClendon, who split reps earlier TY. OSU snapped their 2 gm losing skid after pulling the outright upset vs TX LW in a gm that featured the return of the 'War Pigs' & Barry Sanders honoring the '88 Heisman campaign. This is an extremely even matchup. Against 3 common foes (KU/KSU/TX) OSU is +1 ppg & +63 ypg, while BU is +5 ppg & +68 ypg. This is BU's 1st home gm in 4 wks & the Bears are 6-2 as a HD, but OSU is 23-15-1 as road chalk.

Liberty by 3 MASSACHUSETTS - First Mtg. While UMass had a bye 3 wks this is already their 10th gm TY. This is just Liberty's 8th gm & they are fresh off a bye. UMass can still mathematically become bowl eligible, but that would require them to win out including upsetting Georgia. Liberty is a transitional tm (can't play in a bowl) but still have a goal of 6 wins & "bowl eligibility" needing to win 2 of their final 5 (play Virginia & Auburn). LW UMass despite being without starting QB Ford (CS), pulled out a come from behind win 22-17 over UConn as a 4' pt AF. The Flames went into the bye week winning 3 of their L/4 including upsets at New Mexico (52-43 +7) & at home over Troy (22-16, +9). We expect the Flames to come back healthier & to stay hot and will call for them to get their 4th upset win of the ssn.

Kansas St by 3 over TCU - The visitor has won 3 in a row SU. Both enter with identical records & this game is crucial for Bowl hopes for each. After ply'g their best gm 2 wks ago before their bye, KSU was ambushed LW at OU, all'g a ssn high 702 yds in the 37 pt loss. TCU meanwhile, enters having lost 5 of 6 incl 3 str after LW's shocking loss at KU despite finishing w/27-17 FD & 504-307 yd edges. RB Darius Anderson fumbled on 1&G&L from the 9 w/1:11 remaining. KSU is #106 FBS on OFF avg 44 ypg less than their foes allow, while TCU is #20 FBS on D, holding foes to 93 ypg less than their avg. KSU is on the 2nd of B2B away gms & has the Sunflower Showdown on deck (5-2 ATS gm before), while this is the lone home game in a 4 wk stretch for TCU. TCU is 2-9 as home chalk, while KSU is 23-8 as an AD.

TULSA by 21 over Connecticut - It's homecoming in Tulsa & the Golden Hurricane is ply'g w/revenge after LY's loss in the 1st all-time mtg was UConn's only FBS home win of the ssn. TY enters off an emotional loss vs Tulane where they led the entire gm until 3:46 left 4Q. While both enter with an identical 1-7 SU mark, the similarities end there. TU is just -33 ypg while UConn is -254 ypg. In AAC play TU is -56 ypg, while UConn is -256 ypg. UConn is dead last in the nation in D, all'g 170 ypg more than their foes avg. RB's Shamari Brooks & Corey Taylor are healthy for Tulsa & should easily find running lanes vs a Huskie D all 33 (8.1) in AAC play. TU is home for the 3rd time in 4 wks. UConn is 12-22 as an AD.

CLEMSON by 44 over Louisville - Clemson is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS in this series. The nightmare ssn continued for HC Petrino last week in a 56-35 (-2) home loss to WF. The Cards allowed 368 (7.7) rush yds. QB Pass threw for a car high 358 pass yds but that was against the #115 rated pass eff D and now he takes on Clemson's D which is holding foes to 176 ypg below their ssn avg (#2 in FBS) and the Tigers have our #29 ranked pass eff D. Clemson handed FSU their most lopsided home defeat in school history in a 59-10 (-17) beatdown. The Tigers have held 5 opp's to their ssn low yards. QB Lawrence has a 16-2 ratio and we aren't sure Louisville can get a

UM enters fresh off a bye w/RU on deck. The players have gone out of their way to remind folks they are on a 'revenge tour' TY & have backed up the claim by already beating UW & MSU each by double-digits (+462 yds!). PSU is in the middle of rugged 3 gm stretch, off Iowa w/UW on deck & QB Trace McSorley was out for several series (knee) in LW's physical win. UM has all'd less than 50 yds in the 1H of 3 of their L/5 gms! UM is #1 FBS on D holding foes to 218 ypg below their avg & is also #1 in our PDRI UM is 3-0 as B10 home chalk TY. PSU is 3-8 as an AD.

South Carolina by 3 over MISSISSIPPI - SC ended a 7 game losing streak vs SEC West foes LY by beating Ark 48-22 (+3). Ole Miss is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS vs SEC East foes. The 'Cocks rallied from a 21-9 3Q deficit to beat Tenn last week 27-24 (-8). RB Dowdle went for 140 yds last week for SC and DE Worum ret'd from inj, making an immediate impact with a 4D sk that essentially ended the game. Ole Miss is fresh off a bye, having lost to Aub 31-16 (+4) the wk prior. The Rebels are 0-4 ATS in SEC play TY, and is -104 ypg in those. SC is -23 ypg in SEC play. Ole Miss has the edge on OFF but SC has a huge edge on D, holding foes to 49 ypg below their avg while Ole Miss allows 50 ypg above what their foes avg (#110 in FBS). We will ride the chalk as SC is 5-1 ATS on the road while Ole Miss is 0-4 as a HD.

Utah by 3 over RICE - This is easily the pillow fight of the week with UTEP riding a 20 gm losing streak and Rice has lost their last 16 gms vs FBS foes. The Owls last win of course game last year vs the Miners, 31-14 (+1). The Miners have looked much improved despite the losses TY with a 7 pt loss to LT and a 3 pt loss to NT. UTEP is only -50 ypg in CUSA play while Rice is -192. Both tms come off lopsided losses and UTEP may once again be without QB Metz who sparked the offense to two solid performances before LW's 19-0 (+16) loss vs UAB where they gained just 120 yds. We hate to suggest watching this game, much less making a play on it but we will call for UTEP to end their losing streak and give HC Dimel his first win as Miners HC.

ARKANSAS ST by 14 over South Alabama - LA SAla picked up their first SU win in this series (24-19) after Ark St won the first 5 gms SU (4-1 ATS). Ark St outgained (365-340) & out FD'd (23-18) SAla, but the Jags DEF forced Ark St into 6 TO's & got the win. Ark St now has 3 SBC losses for the 1st time s/2010 and need to win out & get help from other tms to even make the SBC title gm. Ark St is just 3-10 ATS back to last ssn, but is still getting solid offensive output (464 ypg, 29 ppg), but are struggling on DEF, especially against the run (228 ypg all'd). SAla is 2-6 SU (4-4 ATS) TY and 1 of their wins was against an FCS foe. Ark St should bounce back at home by 2 td's.

UAB by 28 over Utsa - UAB already owns 2 shutout wins TY and looks to get their third against the worst OFF in CFB, which avg 245 ypg and 162 ypg less than their foes allow. The Blazers pulled the upset last year on the road 24-19 (+8) but are now heavily favored at home. Last week UAB shutout UTEP while holding them to just 120 yards. RB Brown topped 100 yards for the 4th time TY. DE Garcia-Williams has 9 tfl incl 6.5 sks. Utsa is fresh off a bye, riding a 2 game losing streak. The Blazers hold tms to 95 ypg below their avg (#17 in FBS) and we will take UAB at home where they've won and covered every game since their rebirth (10-0 SU/9-0-1 ATS).

Fau by 4 over FIU - It's the Shula Bowl! FIU has won 4 of the L/7 but FAU dominated LY's mtg 52-24 (-14) in both HC Davis and Kiffin's first time in this game. FAU was the darlings of CUSA and the media's pick to win their division but they've lost 4 of their L/5 and now are fighting just to get to a bowl. FIU has won 6 of their L/7 (only loss expected vs Miami, FL) and control their destiny in the CUSA East. The Panthers are off a 38-17 win over WKU. QB Morgan has an 11-0 ratio in his L/4. FAU continues to have issues at QB with HC Kiffin electing to go with former Ark/SMU QB Rate Peavey last week but he threw for just 115 yds. RB Singletary did rush for 171 (9.0). The dog has owned this series, covering 8 straight with 6 outright upsets until LY so we will go with FAU, who has played the much tougher sked (#86 vs #123) for the upset.

Alabama by 13 over LSU - LSU has lost 7 straight in this series, and the L/5 by DD's (1-4 ATS). Both tms are fresh off a bye. QB Tagavailoa has yet to play a full 4Q game with Bama winning by an avg 38 ppg (+256 ypg) and he has an unbelievable 25-0 ratio while completing 70%. This is by far the best defense and secondary that Tagavailoa has faced TY. LSU holds opponent's to 95 ypg below their avg (#18 in FBS) and their pass D, led by CB Williams is #3 in our pass eff D rankings (14 tfl int's). Bama's D holds foes to 145 ypg below their avg, tops in the FBS but they have given up over 300 yds 3 times. The Tigers will be w/o AA LB Devin White for the 1H (targeting susp). HC Orgeron is 15-4 ATS vs SEC foes and they've covered their L/6 as dogs so we will call for the Tigers to keep this a little closer than expected in a night game in Death Valley.

Fresno St by 16 over UNLV - UNLV has won 3 of the L/4 SU & ATS in this series. LY this gm was tied 16-16 after 3Q and UNLV got 10 4Q pts to pull off the 26-16 (328-292 yd edge) upset. UNLV has now lost 5 in a row SU (0-4 MW) after starting 2-1 TY. Losing QB Rogers to inj was a huge blow for the offense, but the DEF has been the bigger issue. In their 4 gm MW losing streak, they are all'g 545 yds & 50 ppg! Meanwhile Fresno held UH's offense to 65 yds below their ssn avg & 20 pts. In 4 MW gms this ssn Fresno is all'g 301 ypg, 8 ppg and are holding MW foes to 97 yds below their ssn avg. QB McMarilyon (2,142 yds, 70% comp, 18-2 ratio) is leading a Fresno offense that avg's 427 yds & 40 ppg. HC Tedford is now on a 17-3-2 ATS run at Fresno & is 4-0-2 as a road favorite. UNLV just all'd SJSt (#124 offense before LW) to score 50 pts & gain 506 yds. Even w/ a gm at Boise on deck, we still think Fresno takes this one by over 2 TD's.

Utah St by 20 over HAWAII - Utah St has won the L/4 gms in this series both SU & ATS. LY Utah St blanked UH 38-0 at home (475-318 yd edge) as the Aggies ran for 311 yds. LW Utah St bounced back from a poor gm vs WY (won 24-16) and put up 704 yds & 61 pts against NM. QB Love also bounced back (12-28 for 53 yds vs WY) w/ 448 pass yds & 4 TD's. UH dropped their 3rd gm in a row, as they fell to Fresno 50-20 (outgained 562-374). UH QB McDonald is still top 5 in the FBS in pass yds (2,832, 62%, 30-4 ratio) but has failed to top 300 pass yds in 3 straight. This was the 4th straight gm UH failed to gain over 400 yds & score over 23 pts after they were avg'g 494 ypg & 42 ppg in their F/6 gms. Utah St puts up 496 ypg in MW play & UH all's MW foes to gain 120 yds over their ssn avg. Utah St is 5-2 ATS in road gms & UH is just 1-3-1 as a home dog the L/2Y. The Aggies should roll to victory here & are ranked for the 1st time s/2012.

Kent St at BUFFALO - Both are playing their 2nd straight Tues. UB is 7-3 SU vs Kent St since '05 but the visitor has won 8 straight in the series LY the Bulls never trailed but were only up just 20-13 at HT but got the cover as a 7 pt AF scoring the only pts of the 2★ on a late 3Q TD. Kent St is trying to stay out of the MAC East basement while the Bulls are in the hunt for the MAC East Crown, but UB is in a sandwich between the other 2 tms still in the race. LTH KSU led 27-6 into the 4Q & won by 24.

This series has seen a 2-gm sweep in each of the L/9 yrs w/ CAR holding a 12-6 SU (11-7 ATS) advantage in that span incl 14 & 3 pt wins a yr ago. With opposing offenses gashing TB at an alarming rate (33 ppg, 415 ypg), going against them here after ATS losses in 4 of the L/5 is an absolute must! **FORECAST: CAROLINA by 13**

3★ WASHINGTON by 7 over Atlanta - The Falcons were living on the edge prior to their bye week with a pair of narrow victories at home against the Bucs and Giants to get back into contention in the NFC with a 3-4 record. The Redskins meanwhile are sitting atop the NFC East standings coming in following their 3rd consec win LW against the Giants where they helped cash our **4★ NFL October Game of the Month** (RB Peterson 156 tll yds & 2 TD)! In their most recent matchup in ATL back in '15, the Falcons (-7) needed OT to escape with the 25-19 win (418-270 yd edge). With this being just their 3rd game away from home this season and first since Oct 7th in PIT, we'll be backing a Redskins squad in this one that's won their past 3 SU & ATS inside of FedEx Field. **FORECAST: WASHINGTON by 7**

2★ Houston over DENVER - The Texans head to "Mile High" on quite the run following their 5th consecutive victory last Thursday against the Dolphins where QB Watson actually had more TD passes (5) than incompletions (4). The Broncos meanwhile return home after their 2nd loss of the season against the Chiefs a week ago in Arrowhead where they surprisingly finished with a 411-340 yd edge. In their most recent meeting back on MNF in Denver during the '16 campaign, the Broncos delivered the easy 27-9 (-7) win behind a defense that surrendered just 271 yds. With the Broncos having dropped 5 of their past 6 matchups outright and posting just a 5-13-1 ATS mark overall dating back to LY, we'll go ahead and give the lean to the red-hot visitor in this one. **FORECAST: HOUSTON by 4**

OTHER PLAYS

Oakland at SAN FRANCISCO - Thursday - While the Raiders and 49ers once had annual preseason meetings, continuous fights between their respective fan bases has seen their matchups limited to just once every 4 years when the AFC West & NFC West are scheduled to battle it out against each other. The Raiders head to Santa Clara owning a 7-6 regular season advantage including a 24-13 outright win at home as an 8 pt dog back in '14. OAK returned from their bye a week ago inside of the "Black Hole" against the Colts with yet another lackluster effort from their defense who allowed 42 pts & 461 yds in the 14 pt defeat. The 49ers meanwhile blew a 12 pt lead in the 4Q against the Cardinals who connected on a 9 yd TD pass w/34 remaining. With both squads struggling in their assigned roles here (OAK 2-8-1 ATS as an AD, SF 3-11 ATS as a HF), we'll have to wait until closer to gameday before deciding which way to lean. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

MINNESOTA by 10 over Detroit - After seeing their spread streak end at 5 in a row LW at home against the Seahawks who finished with a 413-331 yd edge (+3 TO), the Lions head on the road for the 1st of 2 crucial DIV matchups (at CHI on deck) against the Vikings who have surprisingly dropped 3 of the past 4 in the series including a 14-7 home loss to DET a year ago. Despite massive 423-270 yd edge LW at home against the Saints, a pair of costly TO's saw the Vikings drop a 30-20 contest inside of their home venue. Although the Lions are on a 5-1-1 ATS run vs DIV foes, going against a MIN squad that's 16-4-1 ATS as a HF while covering their L/9 prior to a bye (8 pt avg spread win!) isn't a wise decision.

Kansas City by 11 over CLEVELAND - Following a pair of unsuccessful road trips to TB and PIT (15 pt loss, 421-237 yd deficit), CLE returns home where they've covered 3 of 4 so far in '18 (2-1-1 SU). The Chiefs meanwhile saw their spread streak end at 11 in a row with DEN getting the backdoor cover on a FG w/1:48 remaining in the 30-23 KC win. The last meeting between Baker Mayfield and Patrick Mahomes came back in '16 during a memorable college matchup with Oklahoma and Texas Tech obliterating the NCAA record for combined offensive yards with 1,708! While Mayfield (564 tll yds, 7 TD) and company were able to deliver a victory in that matchup over Mahomes (819 tll yds, 7 TD), expect the red-hot Chiefs QB (4+ TD passes in 5 gms TY!) to earn some redemption here as KC is 17-6 ATS as an AF.

BALTIMORE by 6 over Pittsburgh - Although this series has seen 9 of the past 14 games decided by 4 pts or less, the Ravens were able to draw first blood in a big way back in Wk 4 (12 pt win, 451-284 yd edge) while ending their 3-game losing skid to PIT in the process (had been longest regular ssn skid since '02-'03). BAL does however return home riding a 2-game losing skid following a 15 pt defeat LW in Carolina (4★ Newsletter Winner on the Panthers) where they coughed up the ball on 3 occasions. The Steelers returned from their bye LW at home against the Browns with RB Conner putting up 212 tll yds & 2 TD in the 15 pt win. With BAL needing to get back on track before their bye week, we'll go ahead and call for them to get the cover here as they're 13-5 ATS inside of their division.

MIAMI by 3 over NY Jets - While the Dolphins were able to begin the '18 campaign with a perfect 3-0 SU & ATS mark including an 8 pt win on the road against the Jets, the bottom has fallen out since for MIA with losses in 4 of their past 5 (SU & ATS). In their most recent meeting in HOU with QB Osweiler still under center for the inj'd Tannehill, the Dolphins were outgained by a 427-370 margin in the 19 pt defeat. The Jets meanwhile suffered a 14 pt loss LW in the "Windy City" against the Bears with their offense being held to just 207 tll yds. While the spread loss did move NY's road ATS woes to 3-9-1, a 3 pt lean is all that we can give a Dolphins team that's on just a 3-11-2 ATS mark inside of their home venue.

Chicago by 13 over BUFFALO - Following B2B losses against AFC East members MIA & NE along with a 14 pt win LW at home vs the Jets where they finished with 22-12 FD & 395-207 yd edges, CHI remains in non-conf play for the 4th consec wk to take on a Bills squad that's been outscored (25-12) and outgained (321-234) on the yr. BUF is more than likely sitting on a 3-gm losing skid after road losses in HOU & IND as well as a MNF meeting vs NE after presstime. While BUF is on a 7-2-1 ATS against the AFC, they appear to be clearly overmatched here against a CHI tm that currently owns a half gm lead inside of the NFC North.

SEATTLE by 3 over LA Chargers - The Seahawks earned a big 28-14 win LW in their return from bye behind a 3 TD pass performance from Russell Wilson (413-331 yd egde). They now take on a well-rested Chargers squad who has struggled in their recent bye week returns with just a 3-7 ATS mark. In the '14 matchup in their former home of San Diego, the Chargers (+4) earned the 30-21 upset behind 3 TD passes to Antonio Gates (SD 26-14 FD & 377-288 yd edges). While the Chargers are on a 6-3-1 ATS run in true road contests dating back to LY, going against a Seahawks team that is home for just the 3rd time this ssn is a risky venture.

LA Rams by 2 over NEW ORLEANS - The Saints have partaken in an extremely rough schedule since their return from bye with a narrow win over the Ravens in BAL and a 10 pt win LW in MIN where they surprisingly had 27-17 FD & 423-270 yd deficits (2 key MIN TO's). The Rams meanwhile continued their '18 dominance after a 2 pt win LW against the Packers (23-16 FD & 416-359 yd edges) to move to 8-0 on the year. In LY's meeting in LA, the Rams (-2) finished with 24-14 FD & 415-346 yd edges in the 26-20 win. While the '12 Dolphins will have a vested interest here with a Saints team that's covered 5 in a row coming in, we cannot pull the trigger and go against the Rams in the "Big Easy."

Green Bay at NEW ENGLAND - SNF - Despite 408 combined regular season NFL starts between Aaron Rodgers and Tom Brady, this is just their 2nd (and more than likely final) meeting. In their previous matchup back in '14, the Packers (+3) earned the 26-21 win (Rodgers 368 yds & 2 TD, Brady 245 yds & 2 TD). This is a tough 2-game stretch for the Packers since returning from their bye week as they head to Foxboro following a 2 pt loss in LA against the undefeated Rams (GB key fumble w/1:59 left). While the Patriots (17-7-3 ATS as a HF) do come into this matchup on short rest after a MNF tilt in Buffalo, laying too many points could be costly against Rodgers and company. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Tennessee at DALLAS - MNF - While the Titans did drop their matchup in London a few wks back against the Chargers, Mike Vrabel has proven to be one of the more aggressive HC's in the NFL today by forgoing the PAT w/31 left and going for 2 and the win (TEN 23-14 FD & 390-344 yd edges). The Cowboys also return from their bye week with an extra weapon now in the receiving game following the acquisition of Amari Cooper from the Raiders.
