4★ INDIANA over Old Dominion - ODU's first game vs Indiana and first time facing a Big 10 team. IU is coming off an 11-2 season and return 16 st'rs. They add former Cal QB Mendoza (3004, 69%, 16-6 LY) and have 5 of the top 7 tk'rs back. ODU returns just 11 st'rs but get back QB Joseph and are under 6th year HC Rahne and ODU is 6-2 ATS as a dog of at least 14 pts since '22. Indiana HC Cignetti does not take his foot off the gas and will score early and often if they can. Last season Indiana had no problems covering big point spreads as they were 5-1 ATS when favored DD's and scored 40+ pts 8 times. The Hoosiers only have a game against Kennesaw St on deck so this is no look-ahead spot. Last year we cashed FIVE Key Selection Plays on Indiana and we expect yet another dominant performance from the Hoosiers so they get the call for our top Newsletter play!

FORECAST: INDIANA by 34

3★ OREGON ST over California - Former Pac-12 rivals meet for the 2nd straight year as non-conference foes. Trent Bray is in his 2nd year at Oregon ST after going 5-7 last year. They have 12 starters back (#30 exp) with Duke transfer QB Maalik Murphy (60%, 26-12) taking over. Cal has 14 starters back but is only #97 on our experience chart and lost key starters in the Spring Portal. True Frosh QB Jaron-Keawe Sagopolutele was named the starting QB, beating out OSU's Devin Brown. Last year the Bears were -10' and dominated, 44-7 with a 478-200 yard edge. The Bears have lost 3 of their last 4 in Corvallis and two of those were upsets. The home team is 10-5 SU/ATS in the series. Since '21 the Beavers are 21-5 SU/19-7 ATS in Reser Stadium but 3 of those losses were last year. We still like the more veteran team at home to win by a td.

FORECAST: OREGON ST by 13

3★ RUTGERS over Ohio (THURSDAY) - Rutgers is 2-0 SU & ATS vs Ohio but last met in 2011. The Scarlet Knights are 7-1 SU & ATS in season openers. The Bobcats have struggled in road openers losing 8 straight and going just 1-6-1 ATS. Rutgers has struggled against MAC foes going just 2-3 SU & 1-4 ATS but last year covered vs Akron 49-17 as a 23 pt HF. LY Ohio beat that same Akron team 30-10 as a 9' pt HF. The Knights are 10-5 ATS as a HF since '21, while Bobcats are 5-7-1 ATS as an AD over the same period. HC Greg Schiano is in his 6th year since returning to Rutgers and has 16 returning starters. They includes 9 on an offense that scored 28.9 ppg, their most in over 15 years. LY Ohio won their first MAC Championship since 1968, but their 4 yr HC moved on before their Bowl. New HC Brian Smith did coach their bowl win last year but that is his only HC experience. Ohio returns just 10 starters including just 3 on defense as their lose all of their front 7 starters. With Rutgers experienced offense vs Ohio's inexperienced defense look for the Knights to pull away in the end.

FORECAST: RUTGERS by 24

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Utah over UCLA - These former Pac-12 foes now meet as members of the Big 12 and Big 10 now. Last met in '23 where Utah (-3) won 14-7. Utes have won/covered 6 of the L7 meetings. Utah returns 17 st'rs (#44 experience). Utah added dynamic QB Devon Dampier, who threw for 2,768 yds and ran for 1,166 yds (31 total td) LY at New Mex and the Utes have one of the top OL's in football. They also return a ton of production on DEF and have the big coaching edge here. UCLA upgraded at QB too, adding Nico Iamaleava from Tenn, but they return just 11 st'rs and rank #115 in experience. With a more stable QB situation, this Utah team is dangerous and their fans will invade the Rose Bowl so we see lots of reasons to like the Utes here.

FORECAST: Utah by 13

2★ Eastern Michigan (+) over TEXAS ST - Eastern Michigan never trailed in the only prior meeting winning 59-21 as a 7 pt HF in 2021. The Eagles are just 3-5 SU & 4-4 ATS vs SBC foes. While EM only has an FCS foe on deck Texas St have a huge game at UTSA on deck. While Eastern has just 8 returning starters Texas St only returns 5 which is not the norm for a 3rd year HC as he returned 16 last year and 11 in his rookie season. Texas St is 9-4 SU at home under HC GJ Kinne but they are just 5-6 ATS as a Home Favorite. Last year they had 3 outright losses in that role including a 52-44 loss to Georgia St as 21 pt fav. Twelfth year HC Chris Creighton has led the Eagles to an impressive 30-11 ATS as an AD. With that record and getting around 2 td's, we will take the Eagles and the points.

FORECAST: TEXAS ST by 7

THURSDAY AUGUST 28th

NC STATE by 14 over East Carolina - Rematch of last year's Military Bowl won by ECU 26-21. Wolfpack has 15 returning starters including QB CJ Bailey (2413, 65%, 17-10). ECU only has 6 starters back. Blake Harrell had his Interim tag removed after winning five of their last six last year. These two last met in the regular season in '22 when NCS was -12' but only won 21-20. The Pack won the previous 2 meetings by a combined 92-9 in '18 & '19. NCS was only 1-5 as a HF last year. ECU is 13-6-1 as a road dog since '20. EC is 10-4 ATS vs the ACC and has covered 4 straight road openers. NCS has the experience edge (#50 vs #88) and is out for legit revenge. The angles say take the dog but everything else tells us to lay the points.

Boise St by 3 over USF - First meeting. Boise opens the season on the road for a 5th straight season. They are 1-3 SU/ATS in their previous 4 road openers. Last season they did beat GA Southern 56-45 but didn't cover (-13'). They last played a regular season game in FL back in '21 where they led UCF 24-14 HT but lost 36-31. Boise loses their AA RB but brings back 14 st'rs led by QB Madsen (3018, 62%, 23-6) and DE Virgin-Morgan (10 sk LY). USF is in year 3 under HC Golesh and they return an exp'd team (16 st'rs) and they get all 5 st'rs back on the OL, plus their top 3 tk'rs are all back. We think Boise is the better team, but will have to deal with the heat/humidity of South FL and this USF team is experienced and we'll call for Boise by a FG.

UCF by 21 over Jacksonville St - First meeting. Both teams enter the 2025 season with new coaches as Jax St hired Charles Kelly, but UCF's "new" coach is a familiar face in Scott Frost, who was re-hired and knows this program well. Jax St only returns 6 st'rs and lose their QB, top RB, top WR and their top 7 tk'rs. UCF brings back just 10 st'rs but added good talent in the portal like QB Tayven Jackson. UCF was 10-3 SU/6-4-1 ATS in home games under Frost his 1st stint here. The Bounce House is a tough venue to play in and UCF handled CUSA foe Sam Houston here LY (45-14 win, -21'), the line is over 2 td's but we think UCF gets going early and rolls to an easy win, and they only have an FCS team on deck so nothing to look ahead to.

Wyoming by 3 over AKRON - First meeting. Akron won their only prior game vs a MWC foe 23-21 (+7) over Utah St in the 2015 Idaho Potato Bowl their only ever bowl win. Wyoming is 5-0 SU & 4-1 ATS their last 5 vs MAC foes including 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS in their last 3 Bowls ('21-'23). The Cowboys last trip to play a MAC foe was a 50-43 win at Northern Illinois in '21 covering as a 6' AF. Since '20 Wyoming is 7-3 SU but 4-6 ATS as an AF, with this being the first time in the role under 2nd year HC Jay Sawvel. Akron has won 3 straight home openers but went 0-3 ATS as they were a DD HF vs 3 FCS teams. The Zips are just 6-9 SU & 7-7-1 ATS at Home under 4th year HC Joe Moorhead but that includes 7-3 ATS as a home dog including 2 outright upsets last year over Eastern Michigan and Toledo. In fact the Zips had their first winning season at home (3-2 SU & ATS) since 2017. This is Wyoming's furthest trip East since playing at Connecticut in '21. With the Zips getting over a td here take the point and don't be shocked in Akron pulls the outright upset.

† Nebraska by 3 over Cincinnati - Game in Kansas City. We expect a pro-Nebraska crowd here as it is just 200 miles for them while Cincinnati is over 600 miles away and the Big Red have the better fan base. Nebraska HC Rhule enters year 3 here and they have an exp'd team back with 15 st'rs including 10 on offense led by QB Raiola, however their defense lost all 7 starters from their front 7. Cincy is in year 3 under Satterfield and this looks to be his best team yet. They have 15 st'rs back led by QB Sorsby and Wisconsin transfer RB Walker on offense and stud DT Corleoone on defense. On paper these team appear evenly matched, but the Huskers have the better QB and the crowd edge and that will be the difference here in a close contest.

MINNESOTA by 14 over Buffalo - This is the third meeting between the two schools, and the first since 2017. Minnesota is 2-0 SU against Buffalo, but 0-2 ATS. The Gophers won the most-recent matchup, 17-7, but were -24. Buffalo is 1-11 vs. the Big Ten since '02, but 9-3 ATS. Since the Rutgers win, the Bulls 0-5 SU (2-3 ATS) vs P4 schools. Since '12, the Gophers are 9-1 SU (4-6 ATS) vs MAC schools (their lone loss was to BG in '21). Both teams are coming off bowl wins and enter the year with confidence, but both have new QB's. Minnesota has redshirt rFr Drake Lindsey under center, but do have a top notch O-Line and RB Darius Taylor coming back. Seven starters are back on defense. Buffalo has new QB Taquan Roberson and has RB Henderson and a veteran O-Line back. The Bulls have 9 starters back on defense. Minn does only have FCS NW St on deck but Buffalo is a competitive team and we only have the Gophers by 2 td's.

WISCONSIN by 26 over Miami (OH) - This is only the second meeting between the two schools. They last met in 2015, won by Wisconsin, 58-0 (-31). The RedHawks were outgained in that game, 451-157. In their last 4 vs. P4 schools, Miami is 0-4 SU (1-3 ATS) & the Under is 4-0. Miami has lost 17 straight road openers (0-8 ATS in their last 8). Since '98, the Badgers are 23-0 SU (15-8 ATS) vs MAC schools. Miami does have '23 MAC POY Dequan Finn at QB (transfer from Baylor/Toledo). The RedHawks have 0 starters back from last year's offense and may take some time to gel. The defense does have 5 starters back but Wisconsin has a more veteran team with 14 returning starters and should get solid QB play from Maryland transfer Billy Edwards. Wisconsin is #31 on our Exp Chart and Miami is #96. The Badgers have the nation's toughest schedule to tackle and need every win they can get, and only have Middle Tennessee on deck. Miami is 3-8 as a DD Dog since '17. We are going with the Badgers by just under 4 TDs.

FRIDAY AUGUST 29th

SAN JOSE ST by 20 over Central Michigan - Just their 3rd meeting with San Jose St winning their last mtg but that was in the 1990 California Bowl. Last year under then first year HC Ken Niunmatalolo, San Jose St went 4-1 SU & 5-0 ATS in regular season non-conf games including 3-0 SU & ATS as a HF in those games. While just 4-7 vs MAC foes the Spartans won their last vs the MAC beating Western Michigan 34-6 as a 7' pt HF in 2022. Jim McElwain retired after 7 years leading the Chippewas. Their new HC Matt Drinkall takes over after leading Army's OLine to the Joe Moore Award last year. Central Michigan return a solid core of 10 starters (3 Off, 7 Def) including former Iowa transfer QB Joey Labas (PS#60) who was OFY after 6 starts last year. CM is just 1-6 SU but 4-3 ATS in road openers. With the late start for CM at 10:30 EST and changes on both sides of the ball (new OC & DC) look for San Jose St to open with a solid win.

† Appalachian State by 3 over Charlotte - Game played in Charlotte, but in NFL Panthers stadium. 4th meeting. Met from 2018-20 with App St winning all 3 gms SU, but only covered 1 of them. Both teams enter '25 under new HC's. Charlotte brings in former Ohio HC Tim Albin (led Ohio to first MAC title s/1968!) and they have just 7 starters back and sit at #120 in experience. App St is off their first losing season since 2013 and brought in former NFL OC/QB cch Dowell Loggains as HC. App St also returns just 7 st'rs and they are #117 in experience. App St brings in two P4 QB's to battle it out and added talent throughout the roster. It is tough to gauge how these teams will do when on the field, but they appear close to evenly matched and we'll side with Charlotte to keep this close and the line is sitting around a TD.

WAKE FOREST by 16 over Kennesaw St - First meeting and two head coaches are making their debut. This is KSU's 2nd game vs an ACC foe. They lost to Georgia Tech 45-17 (+19) in '21. WF is on a 0-9 ATS run at home. KSU has lost 10 straight road games but they are on a 7-4 ATS run as an away dog. WF has a new HC in Jake Dickert who brought 2 starting OL's from Washington St. Demond Claiborne (1049, 4.6) is one of the top RB's in the ACC. They have 11 starters back and added transfer QB's Robby Ashford from Auburn and Deshawn Purdie from Charlotte. KSU HC Jerry Mack has 12 starters back. He built his roster up using a lot of D2 and NAIA transfers. WF only has Western Carolina on deck. Kennesaw has the experience edge (#23 vs #76) covered their last 3 when getting over 2 td's last year including an upset win over Liberty and they will keep this within 3 TDs.

BAYLOR by 6 over Auburn - These teams have met 4 times, but the last one came way back in 1976! This is the first time Auburn opens with a true road game since 2002 at USC. Auburn comes in at #58 in experience this season with 15 returning st'rs and they add QB Jackson Arnold from Oklahoma. Baylor is #12 in experience with 18 returning st'rs and are led by QB Robertson (3071, 62%, 28-8) plus return their #1 RB, top 2 WR and 8 st'rs on DEF. Baylor is 6-4 ATS as a home dog since 2021. As of press time Baylor is currently the dog and we think they are the stronger team, plus went 5-1 SU at home a season ago while Auburn was just 1-3 SU on the road last season. We like the Bears to pickup a marquee non-conf win to begin the season.

Univ by 9 over SAM HOUSTON - First meeting. Both teams have a game under their belt. Last week UNLV barely escaped FCS Idaho St. The Rebels trailed 31-24 4Q and they allowed 555 yds including 395 through the air. We cashed our Power Sweep 2H going against Sam Houston last week. The Bearkats were +10 and did lead 24-20 3Q then WKU had 87, 87 & 81 yd td drives. The Rebels have just 5 starters back for first year HC Dan Mullen. Virginia transfer QB Anthony Colandrea threw for 195 last week. SH has 8 starters back and also has a first year HC in Phil Longo. QB Hunter Watson is back for SH but is running a new system and last week he threw for 209 and ran for 91. The Bearkats lost their top rusher, top receiver and their top 16 tacklers. UNLV lost their top 2 QB's, top 2 WR's and 18 of their top 19 tacklers. SH was more impressive last week and are getting nearly 2 td's at home.

Georgia Tech by 6 over COLORADO - First meeting. First time GT will travel this far West for a regular season game since 2013 when they went to BYU (+7) and lost 38-20. First time GT is opening with a true road game since 2020 at FSU, and first true road non-conf game to open a season since playing at NDame in '07. GT gets back 14 st'rs led by dynamic dual-threat QB King (2114 pass, 14-2 ratio, 587 rush, 4.7, 11 td) and they also get 4 of their top 5 tk'rs back. Colorado loses Heisman winner WR/CB Hunter, QB Sanders and they return just 3 st'rs on offense (8 DEF st'rs return). They add QB Salter (5889, 59%, 56-17 L4Y) from Liberty plus add talented frosh QB Juiju Lewis. Colorado is 4-0 ATS as a home dog under HC Sanders but GT HC Key is 9-4 ATS on the road here. These teams appear evenly matched, but we'll call for GT to win a close game.

MICHIGAN ST by 27 over Western Michigan - This is the 10th meeting between the two in-state rivals since 1997. Michigan St is 9-0 SU/6-3 ATS against WMich. Their last meeting was in 2022, won by MSU, 35-13 (-21). The Broncos have lost 9 straight to Big Ten schools (1-8 ATS). In its last 8 road openers, WMU is 1-7 SU (beat Akron in '20) & 3-5 ATS. Since '17, MSU is 7-0 SU (6-1 ATS) vs MAC schools. Lance Taylor enters his 3rd year with WMich and is breaking in a new QB. He has just 7 starters back overall after having a senior laden team last year. They have a lot of new pieces and may need time to gel. The Spartans have Aiden Chiles back at QB and Joe Rossi has a veteran defense, so the Spartans are much improved. MSU is #61 on the Exp Chart and Western is just #104. We're taking MSU by nearly 4 td's.

SATURDAY AUGUST 30th

PURDUE by 17 over Ball St - This is the fifth meeting between the two in-state rivals since 1997, but first since 2010. Purdue is 4-0 SU against Ball St, but 1-3 ATS. Ball St is 0-8 all-time vs Purdue (3-1 ATS last 4 from '97-'10). The Cardinals are 3-28 all-time vs Big Ten schools (wins over Indiana in '08, '11 & '12) but 13-4 ATS since '06. In their last 5 road openers, Ball St is 0-5 SU & ATS. It's the Boilermakers' first game vs a MAC team since beating EMU (+15), 20-19, in '18. New HC Barry Odom is 2-0 SU & ATS in openers at UNLV ('23 & '24) and is 18-10 ATS in non-conf action in his career. Purdue is almost a brand-new team this year, with just 1 starter back from last year's squad and 82 new players! Ball St also has a new head coach and massive turnover, with just 4 starters back from last season. We think Purdue kicks off the Odom Era with a comfortable victory by over 2 td's.

PENN ST by 49 over Nevada - First meeting. Nevada is 2-6 SU (4-3 ATS) vs Big Ten teams (wins over Northwestern in '06 and Purdue in '19). Nevada was shutout in its last 2 B10 games (27-0 loss to Minnesota LY). Since '17, the Wolfpack are 5-8 ATS vs P4 & 7-1 ATS in Week 1. Penn State is 2-0 SU & ATS all-time vs MWC schools (beat SDSU 37-21 in '15 & Boise St 31-14 in last year's Fiesta Bowl). In openers since '16, the Nittany Lions are 8-1 SU (6-3 ATS with 4 straight ATS wins). Penn St is our #1 team this year and #27 on the Exp Chart. Nevada is just #110 on the Exp Chart with 6 returning starters and playing in front of 100,000+ in Happy Valley. Penn St only has FIU and Villanova on deck and they are 3-0 ATS the last two years when laying over 40 points. Jim Knowles' defenses allowed 3 ppg in the first two games last year vs a pair of MAC teams while at Ohio St. We are expecting Penn St. to win big.

MICHIGAN by 39 over New Mexico - First meeting. It's just New Mexico's 3rd game vs. the Big Ten (lost to Rutgers '16 & Wisc '18). New Mexico 0-7 ATS last 7 times it opened season on the road. Since '11, the Wolverines are 9-0 SU (3-6 ATS) vs. MWC teams. Since '14, Michigan is 17-27-2 ATS as a favorite of 20-plus pts (0-2 LY). Michigan went from National Champ in '23 to 6-5, then beat Ohio St and Alabama in its last two games. They have exciting frosh QB Bryce Underwood and did not lose as many players to the NFL as they did the year before. They do have a big game at Oklahoma on deck. New Mexico had an unexpected 5-7 last year, led by an explosive offense but their OC and QB Dampier are both at Utah and their HC is at Utah St. Jason Eck has just 8 returning starters. Wolverines can name the score here.

Temple by 4 over UMass - Temple is 3-0 (1-2 ATS) in series but won & covered their last meeting in '22 28-0 as a 10 pt HF. Teams have combined for just 15 wins the last 3 seasons. Both have struggled in season openers. Minutemen are just 2-8 SU 3-7 ATS, while Owls are just 2-7 SU & 1-8 ATS dropping 5 straight ATS. Temple is also a horrible 1-26 SU & 8-19 ATS on the road since 2020, going 1-1 as an AF. That one win & cover was over MAC Member Akron 45-24 (-6) in '21. Temple is under new HC KC Keeler, who led Sam Houston to a 10-3 record last year including their first ever bowl win and led Delaware to the FCS championship in 2013. He will have 10 returning starters (7 Off, 3 Def) to work with, UMass is also under a new HC in Joe Harasymiak, who was the DC at Rutgers ('22-'24) and was the FCS COY in 2018 leading Maine to the CAA Title. The Minutemen rejoin the MAC this year with just 8 returning starters (4 Off, 4 Def). With both teams trying to rebuild with new HC's look for a game that stays close to the line.

† Tennessee by 20 over Syracuse - The Big Orange meets the Orange in Mercedes Benz Stadium in Atlanta. The Vols are 3-0 all-time vs Syracuse but they haven't met 2001. Cuse is coming off a 10 win season but lost their starting QB, 1,000 yd rusher, three 900+ yd receivers, all 5 starting OL's and 7 of their top 10 tacklers. Vols are looking to prove life moves on after Nico Iamaleava transferred post-spring. They also lost RB Dylan Sampson who broke the Vols' single season rushing record, their top 3 WR's and a #1 DC DE. CB Jermod McCoy is a preseason AA but is coming off a torn ACL and likely won't play. App St transfer Joey Aguilar was named the starter for the Vols while Cuse turns to ND transfer Steve Angeli. Crowd edge will be in the Vols favor. Talent edge is also in the Vols favor. Fran Brown did a great job in year 1 with Syracuse but this looks like a rebuilding year so we will lay the 2 td's.

MARYLAND by 21 over Fau - First meeting. FAU is 1-11 vs. Big Ten teams SU dating back to 2005, but 7-4-1 ATS, including 5-0 in its last five B10 matchups. FAU's only B10 win occurred in 2007, a 42-39 win over Minnesota at a neutral site (Gophers were -7 favorite). FAU's opened last year with a 16-10 (+13) loss at Michigan St. Maryland is coming off a 4-8 (1-8 B10) season. Under HC Mike Locksley, the Terps are 5-0 SU and 2-3 ATS in season openers. They beat UConn, 50-7, LY to win their 19th straight home opener. Maryland returns 6 starters on offense and 4 on defense, but lost starting QB Billy Edwards to Wisconsin. True frosh Malik Washington is competing with UCLA transfer Justyn Martin for the starting QB job. The Terps are just #132 on the Exp Chart but FAU is right with them at #126. Locksley is 13-5 ATS in non-conference play and the Terps need to get off to a strong start after a losing season.

VIRGINIA by 17 over Coastal Carolina - Last year was the first meeting, CC came in 3-0 but UVA was -3 on the road. Cavaliers ran for 384 yards (6.6), led 27-10 at half & won 43-24. CC has covered their last five season openers. Tony Elliott is in year 4 and has his best team yet with 15 starters back and they added North Texas transfer QB Chandler Morris. CC's Tim Beck is in his 3rd year and has 9 returning starters and they added QB MJ Morris who started 7 games between time at NCSt & Maryland. Virginia put up the most yards CC allowed all season last year. They do have their ACC opener at NC State on deck but the Cavaliers can't afford to look ahead if they want to reach a bowl for the first time under Elliott. UVA is laying 12' and they are 6-2 ATS as a double-digit non-conference favorite. CCU is 5-9 ATS as a double-digit dog. Virginia's Oline dominated CC last year and they have 182 career starts so we expecting a similar performance.

Texas by 3 over OHIO ST - CFB Semifinals rematch. Will Ohio St have a National Title hangover? Last year's game swung on Jack Sawyer's 83 yard td after a strip sack and

OSU won 28-14 (-6). Two new QB's will start as the Arch Manning era starts for Texas while OSU turns to rFr Julian Sayin. Buckeyes last hosted Texas in '05 when Longhorns won 25-22. OSU loses 15 NFL draft picks but still loaded with talent. 9 starters return, WR Jeremiah Smith (1315, 17.3) might be the best WR in the country and they get back AA S Caleb Downs on defense. Texas has won their last 6 season openers (5-1 ATS) but the Longhorns are 1-6 ATS vs the B10 since '06. Texas lost 12 NFL draft picks. They have 11 starters returning including #1 tkl'r Anthony Hill and DE Colin Simmons is a preseason AA. Last year Texas knocked off the returning Nat'l Champs, Michigan in 'The Big House' and we think they get another huge win in Big Ten country.

GEORGIA by 35 over Marshall - Only prior meeting came in 2004 where UGA only won 13-3. UGA returns 11 starters and will be breaking in a new starting QB and only have 1 starter back on the OL. Marshall won the Sun Belt last season but lost their HC and a couple dozen transfers to SMiss. Tony Gibson (DC NCSt L6Y) takes over and just 4 st'rs are back. The Herd rank almost dead last in experience (#134) and will We like UGA here by 5 td's but they are favored by almost 40 pts and are just 1-8-1 ATS since 2021 as a 30+ point favorite.

KENTUCKY by 4 over Toledo - Kentucky won the only prior meeting 38-24 as an 11 pt HF in 2019. The Wildcats are not an SEC team that looks past MAC Foes. Since a loss in 2004 they have won 17 straight going 13-4 ATS. That includes a 41-6 win over eventual MAC Champ Ohio last year easily covering as a '19' pt HF despite having a ranked Mississippi on deck. Toledo is an impressive 2-4 SU (3-3 ATS) vs SEC foes including a shocking 41-17 win last year at Miss St as a 10' pt AD. Kentucky is off a 4-8 season just their 2nd losing season since 2016 and brought in 26 transfers in the offseason. Toledo is the #25 most experienced team in the FBS are off their 15th straight non-losing season finishing 8-5 including going 2-0 vs P4 teams. Toledo with a win here & later in the season at a rebuilding Washington St could put them in a driver seat for a playoff spot. With the Rockets getting over a TD here, take the experienced underdog and the points.

UTAH ST by 4 over Utep - 4th meeting. Last met in the 2014 New Mexico Bowl with Utah St winning 21-6. Utah St is under a new HC, but it is veteran coach Bronco Mendenhall. The Aggies come into the season with just 8 returning st'rs and rank #119 in experience. The Miners are in year 2 under HC Scotty Walden, but UTEP has just 11 st'rs back and rank #86 in experience. For his career Utah St HC Mendenhall is 79-37 ATS as a home favorite and 57-37-1 ATS vs non-conf foes. The Aggies are breaking in a ton of new talent, but have the elevation edge here but there's lots of excitement in El Paso with USC/Boise St transfer Malachi Nelson taking over at QB.

WASHINGTON by 28 over Colorado St - First meeting. UW returns 12 st'rs this season and are in year 2 under Jedd Fisch. New QB Demond Williams is expected to be a playmaker as is RB Coleman (1053, 5.5, 10 td LY) and WR Boston (834, 13.2, 9 td LY). CSU enters year 4 under Jay Norvell, but they return just 6 st'rs and are #112 in experience. They do have an exp'd QB in Fowler-Nicolosi, but lost their top RB, top 3 WR and their top 6 tkl'rs on DEF. CSU HC Norvell is 12-21 ATS overall in non-conf games including just 4-10 ATS here. UW was 5-1 ATS at home last season under HC Fisch. UW only has an FCS school on deck, so this is not really a look-ahead spot, and given CSU HC Norvell's track record in non-conf gms, we'll lean with UW.

ARIZONA by 14 over Hawaii - 7th meeting. Ariz is 5-1 all-time, but in their last meeting back in '19 UH (+11) pulled the outright upset at home over Ariz 45-38. Ariz is in year 2 under HC Brennan and they are off a disappointing 4-8 ssn. Ariz returns 16 st'rs incl dynamic QB Fifta (2958, 61%, 18-12) plus add talented transfers at WR. Ariz comes into the ssn #12 in experience. Hawaii played last week vs Stanford and pulled out a win on a fg at the end of regulation. They have 15 st'rs back but are breaking in a new QB, but have a talented WR room and their top 5 tkl'rs from '24 all return. Since 2023 UH is 3-6 ATS as a road underdog, but Ariz HC Brennan is just 12-19 ATS in his career in non-conf games. We will call for UH to cover the spread as it is over 2 td's now.

Georgia Southern by 7 over FRESNO ST - First meeting. GS travelled out west last season and faced Nevada, where they won 20-17 despite being -213 yds. GS enters year 4 under HC Clay Helton and this is his best team yet here (#29 experience) led by QB French (2831, 66%, 17-11), plus they have 7 st'rs back on defense. Fresno played last week at Kansas lost 31-7 (+14). The Bulldogs are starting former Temple QB EJ Warner, but just 9 total st'rs are back and Fresno is in year 1 under HC Entz. GS was 4-2 ATS on the road last season, and pulled 3 outright upsets. They were the slight dog as of presstime, but are now slight favorites. We lean with the more veteran team here to go on the road and get the win.

Mississippi St by 7 over SOUTHERN MISS - 32nd all-time meeting, but have only met 4 times since 1990. They last met in 2023 and S.Miss (+18) trailed just 26-20 mid 4Q but Miss St scored 2 late td's incl a pick-6 to get the cover, winning 41-20. Miss St returns 16 st'rs (#9 experience) led by QB Shapen, their top 2 RB's and 5 st'rs on the OL, plus 5 of their top 7 tkl'rs on DEF. SMiss brought in Charles Huff as the new HC. He led Marshall to their 1st SBC title LY and brings over several of those players led by QB Braylon Braxton (1624, 60%, 19-2 pass, 610 rush, 4.6) and 5 WR's that were at Marshall LY. HC Huff pulled an upset of Notre Dame in '22 and VA Tech in '23 so is no stranger to those. SMiss is getting DD's but the team and crowd will be fired up to prove themselves and we expect a close game.

The Green Wave went 9-5 last year and were +82 ypg. They have 14 starters returning but must replace their starting QB, a 1,400 yd rusher and their top five receivers and #1 tk'l'r. BYU transfer QB Jake Retzlaff was a late addition and appears he has the edge over Iowa transfer Brendan Sullivan. David Braun is in his 3rd year at NW and is coming off a 4-8 season and were -77 ypg. The Wildcats brought in SMU transfer QB Preston Stone who threw for 3,197 and 28 td's in '23. This is a rare spot where a B10 team is getting nearly a td vs a G5 foe. The Wildcats pulled two road upsets last year and with Stone at the helm we think they are capable of pulling another, making this our Underdog POW!

FORECAST: Northwestern by 3

OLE MISS by 42 over Georgia St - First meeting. Ole Miss has won their last two ssn openers by a combined 146-7 but those were vs FCS teams. They last opened with a Sun Belt team in '22 and only won 28-10 (-21) vs Troy. Rebels are coming off a 10 win season and have 12 starters back. QB Austin Simmons steps in but they must replace their top 2 rushers, top two WR's, their starting TE, 4 starting OL's and 11 of their top 13 tacklers. Naturally Kiffin added talent in the Portal and the defense is still strong with Suntarine Perkins (10.5 sk) leading the way. Georgia St was 3-9 last year (-30 ypg) but did have a win over a SEC foe, beating Vandy at home and they also upset Texas St late in the season. GSt has 10 starters back for 2nd year HC Dell McGee. Kiffin is 4-1 ATS at Ole Miss when favored by more than 35 points so we don't expect any hold back despite their SEC opener on deck.

Alabama by 14 over FLORIDA ST - This is the 5th meeting between these two blue-bloods and first-ever in Tallahassee. Bama is 4-1 SU in the series, Tide won 24-7 in the last meeting back in '17. Bama is coming a 9-4 season and Kalen DeBoer is in his 2nd year. They return 15 starters including AA WR Ryan Williams (865, 18.0). RB Jam Miller returns but was injured last week and will miss this game. FSU has 16 starters back and should easily improve after a disastrous 2-10 season. HC Norvell brought in BC transfer QB Thomas Castellanos and they get Bama transfer RB Roydeil Williams back from injury. Last year Bama was +90 ypg while FSU was -116 and despite an improved roster, the Tide are clearly the better team and Kalen DeBoer is 14-3-1 ATS vs non-conf foes. Bama has won it's last 23 season openers (18-5 ATS) but FSU is much improved and we think this line is where it should be.

TEXAS A&M by 31 over Utsa - A&M has won two previous meetings but UTSA is 2-0. Last meeting was in '19 and UTSA (+38) covered on a Pick-6 with 4:53 left. A&M is 8-2 SU/7-3 ATS in season openers. This is UTSA's 3rd straight year playing an SEC foe. Last year they were crushed by Texas 56-7 (+35) and in '23 they were +24 and lost at Tenn 45-14. A&M was 8-5 SU but 3-10 ATS last year, their first under HC Mike Elko. They have a loaded roster with 15 starters back (#6 most exp'd) including under-the-radar QB Marcel Reed, RB Le'Veon Moss and they return their top 6 tacklers. UTSA was 7-6 last year and +76 ypg. HC Traylor has 9 starters back on offense including QB Owen McCown (63%, 25-10) but only 2 starters from a D that allowed 382 ypg. A&M only has Utah St on deck so no look ahead here. Traylor is only 5-10 ATS vs non-conf the last 3 years. Aggies are laying just over 3 td's, Elko wants a strong start to '25 and he gets it here.

LOUISIANA by 10 over Rice - Last met in 2022 where Rice (+11') trailed 14-13 HT but with a strong 2H pulled the outright upset 33-21. Rice is led by new HC Scott Abell and he is bringing the option offense with him that he ran at FCS Davidson. Rice returns just 7 st'r's and are #95 in experience. LA is in year 4 under HC Desormeaux and they are fresh off a 10-4 season and a trip to the SBC title game LY. The Cajuns also return just 7 st'r's (#83 experience) and they bring in former LSU/Ole Miss QB Walker Howard. LA is just 3-6 ATS as a DD favorite the last 2 seasons. LA had extra time to prep for the option, but we like Rice to hang around and make a game of this

USC by 41 over Missouri St - First meeting. HC Ryan Beard's Missouri St is playing their first ever FBS game. The Bears went 8-4 and did play in the FCS meat grinder of the Missouri Valley last year. They were outgained 435-320 last year at Ball St and lost 42-34 (+2). They have 9 starters back including 3Y starting QB Jacob Clark (orig Minn) who threw for 3,604 (70%, 26-6) last year. USC has 16 starters back and have less questions at QB now that they aren't replacing the first overall draft choice like last year. Jayden Maiava took over midseason last year and threw 11 td passes. Trojans only have Georgia Southern on deck and the Trojans did go 3-0 ATS as double-digit chalk last year including a 48-0 win over Utah St. Trojans are laying 5 TDs and we think they clear that number.

Clemson has the experience edge (#2 vs #47). They have the better Oline and we think the defense is much improved under new DC Tom Allen. They have 3 potential Top 10 picks on their Dline. LSU is just 7-5 SU/4-8 ATS on the road under Brian Kelly while Clemson is 63-5 SU at home so the home team hands LSU another loss in a season opener.

† **South Carolina by 4 over Virginia Tech** - This game is being played in Mercedes Benz Stadium in Atlanta, GA. Shane Beamer was a VT assistant under his legendary father from '11-'15. This is the first meeting between these two since 1991. SC is coming off a 9 win season and has 12 starters back including All-SEC QB LaNorris Sellers but they lose their top rusher, top receiver and their top five tacklers. VT has 12 starters back including QB Kyrion Drones but were only 6-7 last year and lost at Vandy in the opener. Since '04 VT is 2-8 SU/3-7 ATS vs the SEC but they are getting more than a td here and this should be a tight game.

Notre Dame by 7 over MIAMI,FL - Last year Miami had the benefit of not playing a single ranked team in the regular season. This year they open with #5 Notre Dame. ND is 17-8-1 all-time in this series including a win in the infamous 'Catholics vs Convicts' game in 1988. Last meeting was also in Coral Gables, Canes were +3' but won 41-8. Irish are off a trip to the CFB National Title game. 14 starters return and rFR CJ Carr will take over as their starting QB. UM was 9-0 and #4 last year but lost 3 of their last 4. UGA transfer Carson Beck takes over at QB. The 'Canes have a stout run D led by DE Rueben Bain that allowed just 113 (3.7). They have a big test against ND's Preseason AA RB Jeremiyah Love (1125, 6.9). Miami has the experience edge (#21 vs #64) but Notre Dame has proven they can win big games. Miami is 1-13 SU/3-11 ATS vs top 10 teams since 2010.

They return 14 st'r's overall and rank #21 in experience, led by returning QB Hoover (3949, 67%, 27-11) and an exp'd defense (8 st'r's back).
