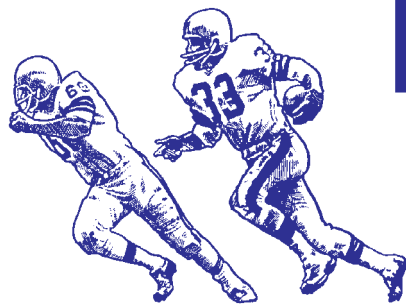

KEY SELECTIONS

4★ BOISE ST over Fresno St - Longtime rivals have split 4 MWC title games since '14. Boise St has regrouped from losses at USF and Notre Dame to sit at 6-2 SU & 4-3-1 ATS. Broncos are once again the MWC fav and after Memphis beat USF, they're still in contention for the G5 playoff berth. Boise has won by an avg of 49-21 and is +220 ypg at home, and the D allows 88ppg less than opp avg (#19 FBS). The Bronco defense will enjoy a mismatch against Fresno St. Bulldogs benched QB EJ Warner last wk to spark the offense against SD St. But Carson Conklin had 0-2 ratio and FSU was blanked 23-0 to fall to 5-3 and a 4th straight ATS loss. D is only giving up 24ppg and has played well when offensive TO's don't back the unit into a corner. The Fresno St defense will keep this one from getting out of control. But the Bulldogs lack the scoring punch to compete, and eventually picks & fumbles will do them in. Boise wins by over 4 td's in a low-scoring gm. **FORECAST: BOISE ST by 31**

3★ UTAH over Cincinnati - First mtg and Cincinnati's longest road. This is the biggest gm of the Scott Satterfield era at Cincy. Since losing the opener to Nebraska, Bearcats have won 7 straight and steadily climbed the polls. The offense averages 38ppg behind a solid ground gm (195 ypg, 5.9) and the playmaking of QB Brendan Sorsby (27 total td's, 1 int). But Cincy's toughest road gm was at Kansas and their best win was over Iowa St which was riddled with injuries and has since faded. This is the kind of measuring stick gm Bearcats haven't faced since Wk 1. Utah's 6-2 and fresh off a 53-7 thumping of Utah. Utes are always tough at home and this year are +27ppg and +193pg in SLC. They're top 10 in both offensive ypg above opp defenses avg and at holding opp offenses below their ypg norm. QB Devon Dampier missed the Colorado gm, but the offense had a ssn-high 587 yds with true frosh Byrd Ficklin running things. This is a very good Cincinnati mt but they're about to run into a buzzsaw and a wild scene at Rice-Eccles Stadium. **FORECAST: UTAH by 14**

3★ NEBRASKA over USC - USC has never lost to Nebraska (5-0-1 all-time). LY at the Coliseum, game tied at half but USC (-7) pulled away in the second half for a 28-20 win. Trojans outgained Huskers 441-310 in the win. Under HC Riley, SC 3-1 SU (1-3 ATS) after bye. This is 3rd time Nebraska is hosting Trojans (lost 31-21 in '69 & 49-31 in '07). Nebraska is playing a 5th straight week and USC is fresh off a bye. LW Nebraska got a touchdown with 2:44 left to defeat Northwestern, 28-21 (-7). Riley is 9-21-1 ATS as an AF (3-12 as an AF at USC), but 5-1 SU as an AD. USC is 1-15 ATS in ET or CT. Huskers defense combined for 16 sacks in their two losses. With that, we are leaning toward the Cornhuskers by 3 at home. **FORECAST: NEBRASKA by 3**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ SAN DIEGO ST over Wyoming - San Diego St has won 3 straight in series including LY in Laramie, 27-24. Aztecs are one of the G5's hottest tms. They've won and covered 5 straight, capped by last wk's 23-0 road blanking of Fresno. HC Lewis is known for offense but his D allows just 10 ppg (#2 FBS), ranks #9 in pass efficiency D and gives up 2.9 ypc. The offense, which misfired in September, has had more than 200 yds rushing in 3 consecutive games. Lucky Sutton leads the way with 657 (5.3). SD St returns home for the first time in almost a month. Wyoming is 4-4 with hopes for a bowl. Cowboys just handled Colorado St, 28-0, but are 1-2 on the road with the win over Akron, 10-0. Wyoming gains 59ppg below foes defensive avg (#120) so this will be a long evening for QB Kaden Anderson and his supporting cast. Neither team will pop big plays or do much scoring, but SD St's elite D and momentum will fuel a win by more than 2 td's. **FORECAST: SAN DIEGO ST by 17**

2★ † Georgia over Florida - This has been a lopsided series with just 1 game decided by 7 points or less in the last 11 meetings. UGA has won 4 straight in the series for the first time since '78-'83. Florida did cover LY as 14' pt dogs. They only trailed 27-20 and UGA scored w/3:03 left but UGA did finish w/4 455-228 yd edge. Both tms are fresh off a bye. Georgia has won 3 straight as they've been a 2nd half team all season. They trailed at half at Tenn, Aub and vs Ole Miss but they won all 3 and covered vs Aub & Ole Miss. Dawgs are +115 ypg and +60 vs the SEC. FL finally gave Billy Napier the ole heave-ho. The Interim HC is WR Ceh Billy Gonzales. Gators beat Miss St and and Miss St in the Swamp but they've lost all 3 games away from home at LSU (5 int's), Miami (outg'd 344-141) and A&M. The average MOV in this series is 19.9 ppg and UGA is only laying 7'. The Interim HC bump won't help the Gators here as there players are starting to think about their next destination and Georgia won't have mercy. **FORECAST: Georgia by 16**

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 29th

Jacksonville St by 3 over MIDDE TENNESSEE - Jax St is 2-0 SU/ATS vs MT. LY they ran for 438 yards and won 42-20 (-20'). LTH Jax St won 45-30 (+3). MT is 1-6 this year and 0-3 in CUSA play yet they are +52 ypg vs CUSA foes while Jax St is 3-0 in CUSA play but yard are even in those games. LW they lost at Delaware 31-28 (+9). The Gamecocks are rushing for 276 (5.6) and RB Cam Cook has 949 (5.9). MT has held their last 2 foes under 80 rush yards and are only giving up 143 (3.8). MT's QB Nicholas Vattiatto has an 11-5 ratio. Jax St is laying 5' points here. MT's last two losses are by a combined 5 points. We won't call for the upset but MT keeps games close.

Fiu by 3 over MISSOURI ST - First meeting. MSU is 4-3 and they just won B2B on the road. The Bears beat MT on a GW fg then LW QB Jacob Clark returned from injury and threw for 283 yards as they needed OT to beat NMSt. FIU had their best performance two games ago when they beat WKU 25-6 (+10) on the road then last week they were +3 at home vs a Kennesaw St team that had lost 13 straight road games. FIU trailed 24-7 2Q, got back within 7 3Q but lost 45-26. FIU put up a season high 503 yards in the loss. RB Kejon Owens is #2 in CUSA with 809 (6.9). MSU is allowing 141 rush ypg (4.9) but only 109 (4.1) in CUSA play and they held MT and NMSt under 90 rush yds. All 3 of MSU's CUSA games have been decided by 7 or less so this should be yet another close game and FIU's win at WKU shows they can handle the travel so we are calling for the upset.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 30th

Marshall by 10 over COASTAL CAROLINA - Fourth all-time mtg. Marshall (-8) won last yr at home 31-19. Both tms looking to maintain momentum before last wk's bye. Herd won b2b home upsets over ODU & Texas St to get to 4-3 SU & 5-2 ATS. Over last 4 gms, Marshall avg 45ppg and gained at least 70ppg above foes def avg. QB Carlos Del Rio-Wilson has 12-1 ratio and leads in rushing with 360 yds. The D has been slower to rebuild, allowing opp to gain 73 ypg above their avg (#124 FBS). However, Herd's weakness is pass D which won't get exposed by Coastal Carolina (6-8 ratio & #133 in pass eff). Chants have gutted out b2b wins to inch above .500 despite ranking #129 in off ypg below opp avg and #111 in defensive ypg above opp avg. CCU has gotten a spark from JUCO QB Samari Collier who's rushed for 160 yds last 2 gms but is a poor passer. Herd will stack the box to shut down Collier and earn 3rd straight win behind the surging offense.

UTSA by 3 over Tulane - These two last met in '23 as Tulane won 16-7 (-3') in New Orleans. Tulane hasn't played in San Antonio since '13. Both tms are fresh off a bye. UTSA is 31-5 SU at home under Traylor including 23-0 SU/16-7 ATS at home vs Conference foes! Tulane is 6-1 SU/4-3 ATS this year but they are 1-2 ATS on the road this year. QB McCown has a 13-4 ratio and RB Henry leads the AAC with 868 (8.3). UTSA is only 3-4 this year but they started 3-5 last year then

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won 3 straight at home including over Memphis and North Texas. Tulane's last two wins were by just 7 points each and the Green Wave rank dead last in the American in Red Zone td conversions, scoring 14 td's in 30 attempts. Sumrall is 11-2-1 as an AF but Traylor is 6-1 as a home dog. Traylor keeps his streak alive as UTSA pulls the upset.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 31st

Memphis by 10 over RICE - Memphis has won the last two meetings. Last year Memphis beat Rice 27-20 (-9). QB Brendon Lewis returned from injury LW and Memphis upset USF 34-31 (+5'). The Tigers trailed 31-17 4Q and outscored USF 17-0 in the 4Q. Rice was our Big Dog Comp play, (Free on Button #9 on Thursdays!) and the Owls pulled the outright upset, beating UConn 37-34 (+10.5) in OT. Rice is 4-4 SU/ATS. This is Memphis' first game against the option this year. Last year they lost at Navy 56-44 and allowed 361 rush (9.3). The situation greatly favors the underdog Owls. Memphis is off a huge win, traveling to face the option on short rest and they have Tulane on deck. Silverfield is 7-10 as a road favorite. Rice shortens the game and keeps it closer than expected.

North Carolina by 3 over SYRACUSE - These two last met in '23 when UNC won 40-7 (-9'). Two straight near upsets for NC leaves them 0-3 in ACC play but they are clearly improving. LW they had a 353-259 yd edge vs Cuse but fumbled at the goal line early then missed the GW 2 pt conv in OT. The Tar Heels D has allowed 294 and 259 in their last 2 games. Cuse has lost 4 straight, with their loss by 13 points vs SMU but they trailed that game 31-3 4Q then scored 2 late td's. LW Cuse played a banged up GTech team missing 3 starters and the Orange were still shellacked 41-16 (+17) and outgained 543-381. QB Rickie Collins now has a 6-8 ratio. It took a while for NC's transfers to gel. It's only a matter of time until Bill Belichick gets his first ACC win and we think it happens here against a CUse team that is -22 ppg/95 ypg since QB Angeli got hurt. Tar Heels defense is the difference and they win a close low scoring game.

LOUISIANA TECH by 20 over Sam Houston - LT is 0-2 SU in this series but they did cover LY as 10 pt dogs, losing 9-3 and they had a 312-268 yd edge. The Bulldogs started 4-1 and looked like the best team in CUSA but now they've lost B2B. LW they settled for 4 fg's and missed 2 vs WKU. LT finished w/a 449-340 yd edge but lost 28-27 in OT. SH is 0-7 under 1st year HC Phil Longo. The Bearkats have six losses by 17 points or more including vs UTEP 2 weeks ago, 35-17 (+2'). SH is -97 ypg in CUSA play while LT is +60. The Bulldogs have the best D in CUSA. They are #1, 19 ppg/353 ypg while SH is dead last, allowing 39 ppg/456 ypg. Normally we wouldn't subscribe to laying over 2 td's in the unpredictable CUSA, but SH has been dreadful and LT should clear this line.

SATURDAY November 1st

SOUTH ALABAMA by 3 over Louisiana - Visitor has won 4 str in series, Louisiana has taken 4 in a row in Mobile. However, at 2-6 SU & 3-5 ATS Cajuns mired in their worst ssn in a decade. They've lost 3 straight and are 0-4 SU & 1-3 ATS on the road. They were competitive during the recent 4-gm stretch vs SBC's top tms and outgained Troy 371-345 in last wk's 35-23 loss. But Louisiana is -154ppg away from home and allows 41 more ypg than foes avg (#106 FBS). USA has momentum after beating Georgia St 38-31 last Thurs. Jags had ssn-high 468 yds and scored 10pts in final 5:39 for their 2nd win. However, they're 0-3 in Mobile against FBS tms. USA has 2 extra days of rest and the more consistent QB. Bishop Davenport has an 11-4 ratio and weapons like RB Kentrel Bullock (681, 4.7) & WR Devin Voisin (642, 13.4). Cajuns are led by Lunch Winfield (51%, 5-4). With momentum and the more balanced offense, USA earns 2nd straight win.

East Carolina by 1 over TEMPLE - EC has won 4 straight in this series by 23 ppg and they have covered 4 of the last 5. Temple is 5-3 SU/6-2 ATS and their losses are to Oklahoma, GTech and Navy by 1 pt. The Owls are +44 ypg in AAC play but didn't cover LW at Tulsa when they won 38-37 (-5). EC is 4-3 SU/ATS and their losses are to NCSt, BYU and Tulane. The Pirates are +64 ypg in AAC play. They are fresh off a bye after beating that same Tulsa team at home 41-27 w/a 568-398 yd edge. Temple QB Evan Simon is hitting 63% w/a 21-0 ratio! EC's Katin Houser is hitting 66% w/a 10-4 ratio. EC has the edge on D but they are only #81 in our Pass D rankings (62%, 6-3) while Temple is #64 (58%, 11-6). Temple has a decent ST's edge. HC Keeler is 8-2 as a home dog while EC is 5-7 as an AF. We like both teams so we lean with the home dog to cover.

TENNESSEE by 3 over Oklahoma - LY OK was missing their top 5 WR's and Tenn led 19-3 at half. OK switched QB's late and scored 2 td's in a 25-15 (+7) loss. OK was outplayed on their home field by Ole Miss LW in a 34-26 (-5) loss. QB Mateer was better in his 3rd game off the injury but still only has an 8-6 ratio and OK's D allowed a season high 431 yards including 315 through the air. Tenn beat KY LW 56-34 but they allowed KY to put up a season high 330 pass yards (avg just 207). Vols have a big edge on offense (46 ppg/510 ypg) but OK has a huge edge on D (13 ppg/240 ypg). Venable is 5-2 ATS off a SU loss. Sooners are #10 in pass D efficiency while Vols are #105. This is a night game in Knoxville so the home crowd will be fired up for what's essentially a playoff elimination game. The defensive issues for the Vols and Aguilar's capacity for TO's are scary but we can't pick OK to pull the upset.

Notre Dame by 38 over BOSTON COLLEGE - ND dominates the ACC (18-4 ATS) and this game should be no exception. The Irish are fresh off a bye, they've won 5 straight and four of those wins are by 21 points or more. BC is 0-7 SU vs FBS teams, though the offense has been better since switching to QB Grayson James (52%, 6-3). RB Turbo Richard missed their last game but BC ended an 0-5 ATS streak, only losing 38-24 (+25') at L'ville. In their L/4 the Eagles are -25 ppg and -194 ypg while the Irish are +26 ppg/+169 ypg in their L/4! ND RB Jeremiah Love should go off against a BC D that allowed 317 (10.2) rush LW and 202 (5.7) in their L/4. This is BC's 6th straight week playing so ND is the fresher team with a huge talent edge. Irish are laying just over 4 td's and we think they clear the line easily.

Clemson by 10 over Duke - Duke is 4-3 but only 1 ACC loss so the Blue Devils are among 7 teams with a legit shot at the ACC Title game. Clemson is 3-4 and 3 of their losses are in ACC play so they are just fighting for bowl eligibility. Both tms are fresh off a bye. Duke dominated the 1H in the stats (238-110 yds) 2 wks ago vs Gtech but lost 27-18. Clemson was w/o QB Klubnik in their 35-24 loss at home to SMU. The defense was a huge disappointment, allowing 429 yds including 290 passing. Klubnik could return this week. Duke won their L/2 road games but those were against reeling Syracuse and Cal and they lost at Tulane earlier this year. Clemson has a big talent edge and they are only laying 3'. We like the home team by DD's in a circle-the-wagons game.

FLORIDA ST by 14 over Wake Forest - FSU had won 7 straight from '12-'18 then WF won 3 straight but FSU won the last meeting in '23, 41-16 (-21). The 'Noles have lost 4 straight but Mike Norvell is still the HC. The 'Noles are fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they were clearly the better team but lost at Stanford 20-13 despite a 444-293 yd edge. WF has been a big surprise in Jake Dickert's first year at WF. They are 5-2 SU/ATS and +83 ypg (+19 vs ACC). LW they held SMU to a ssn lows of 246 yds and 8 FD's and won 13-12. Deacons are in a flat spot coming off the upset win and now on the road while FSU is more rested and at home. FSU has ply'd the tougher sked (#40 vs #69). 'Noles win by 2 td's.

Indiana by 28 over MARYLAND - Hoosiers are 6-5 vs Terps as B10 members. IU snapped MD's 3-gm win streak with LY's 42-28 home win as 7-pt fav. Last time here in '23, Hoosiers (+14) fell 44-17 in a game that was 37-3 at start of 3Q. Maryland has won last 2 at home (44-17 as 14-pt favorite in '23). Indiana opened 7-0 SU and 5-2 ATS with a blowout 63-10 home win over Top 10 Illinois & a 30-20 road win at Oregon. LW, Indy blew out UCLA, 56-6 (-26). Maryland opened up 4-0 then blew 4Q leads vs Washington, Nebraska and a 3Q lead vs UCLA and were 0-3 in B10 play. They are fresh off a bye. Since '19, Terps 0-10 SU & 2-8 ATS off bye weeks (3 upset losses). Cignetti is 9-3 ATS as an AF and Locksley 9-8 ATS as a HD (2-0 TY) and 6-13 ATS vs ranked teams. Indiana is 10-4 ATS under Cignetti, & Cignetti is 21-9 ATS vs. conf. foes in his career. Locksley's record ATS at Maryland is 14-21-1. We see the Hoosiers remaining red-hot here.

MICHIGAN by 27 over Purdue - Purdue has visited Michigan twice since '09 (lost '11 & '23). Last time here, Boilers (+32) back door covered on TD pass with 18 sec left of 41-13 loss. Since '14 Purdue 12-6 as conf dog of 20+ pts. Since '00, Mich 11-3 SU vs Purdue, winning last 6 by 22 ppg. In Ann Arbor, UM has won 19 of 20 dating back to '69 (lost '09 as 6' fav). As conf favorite of 20+ pts, they are 8-8-2 ATS since '18. Purdue HC Odom brought his 2023 UNLV team into the Big House to face eventual NC Michigan and was +38 and covered, losing 35-7. Michigan is off 4 big games but has a bye on deck. LW, RB Haynes returned for Michigan and ran for 152 yards, but MSU got a TD with :05 left for another back-door cover, 31-20 (-13'). Purdue was pesky early on, covering vs USC and were respectable vs ND & Illinois. LW, Purdue fell to Rutgers on a FG w/ :00 left, 27-24 (-3), despite a 543-345 yd edge. We believe a last-second FG won't be the difference in this one.

Georgia Tech by 3 over NC STATE - NCST has covered the L/2 but GT is 12-4 SU since '97. The 'Jackets won LY 30-29 but were -9. GT is 8-0 SU/6-2 ATS and one of their non-covers was a late backdoor vs Temple. NCST is 4-4 SU/3-5 ATS and 3 of their losses are by DD's. The 'Pack gave up 53 points and 529 yds LW at Pitt in a 19 pt loss (+6). NCST did beat UVA at home but was outgained by 98 yds and they lost in Raleigh to VTech 23-21 (-123 yds). All of the stats clearly point to laying the points with GT as road chalk but they are playing with unbeaten pressure and NCST has plyd the tougher sked (#35 vs #68). Wolfpack faithful will be fired up for a night game and a chance to upset a top 10 team so the crowd should be lively and this will be close.

OHIO ST by 24 over Penn St - Lions last series win was '16 upset of #2 OSU (-19). PS has lost 6 straight in the Shoe & 8 straight overall. Last time here '23, PS (+4) held to season low 49 rush yds in 20-12 loss. HC Franklin was 1-16 SU vs AP Top 5. OSU has won 8 straight & 12 of last 13 (3-5 ATS during streak). Six of last 7 have gone under total. LY, OSU (-3) held PS to season low 270 yds in 20-13 road win but Penn St was SOD at the 1 with 5:13 left at home. Ohio St has been even better than expected at 7-0 SU and 6-1 ATS winning their B10 games by an 34-6 average and +190 ypg. The D is #1 in the country, holding foes to 170 ypg below their average and QB Sayin his hitting 80% with a 19-3 ratio. Penn St has been a disappointment. HC Franklin was fired as they are 0-4 SU in B10 play with the losses by a combined 13 points! They are -70 ypg in B10 play and their DC Knowles, who came over from OSU, has a unit holding foes to 57 ypg below their average. QB Allar is OFY and Grunkemeyer makes his 2nd road start. This game isn't as big as we thought it would be during the preseason.

Louisville by 4 over VIRGINIA TECH - LY was only their 2nd meeting as ACC foes and L'ville won 34-3 (-9) at home. This is UL's first trip to Blacksburg since 1991. Cards' are 6-1 SU but only 2-5 ATS. LW they were -25' but only beat BC 38-24. VT gets extra rest and they are 3-2 SU/2-3 ATS under Interim HC Phillip Montgomery. Hokies QB Kyron Drones is hitting 60% w/a 14-6 ratio but faces UL's #11 ranked pass D (56%, 8-12). UL RB Isaac Brown has 652 (8.7) and LW went for 205 vs BC. VT has held 4 of their L/5 foes under 100 rush yards. UL is laying DD's on the road. They did beat Miami in Coral Gables but Brohm is only 2-5 as an AF here and VT will keep it closer than expected.

Buffalo by 3 over BOWLING GREEN - Bulls are 5-2 SU s/17 & 7-3 ATS s/14 vs Falcons. Visitor has won & covered 3 straight. BG has played the tougher schedule (#85-131). Bulls after covering their F/2 (1-1 SU) are 3-3 SU but just 1-5 ATS incl 3-1 SU but 0-4 ATS in MAC play. BG is 3-5 SU & 5-3 ATS but are 1-3 SU & ATS in MAC play. Against their only common foe Kent St: UB (-23) won 31-28 being outgained 467-423. They trailed 14-0 2Q & 28-24 4Q before GW td w/1:03 left. LW BG (-8) led 21-3 3Q but already down to 3 string QB Baron May, lost him for the ssn. BG then allowed final 21 pts (GW td w/3:15 left) to lose 24-21 despite a 379-294 yd edge. BG is down to 4th string QB Hunter Najm (2-4-30 LW) who is taking first tm reps (#1 QB Pyne dressed LW but DNP). We will lean with the Bulls who have their #1 QB back and are still in MAC race.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 6 over Central Michigan - "Battle for Victory Cannon" and part of Michigan MAC Championship (also incl EM). Visitor was 9-2 ATS from '12-'22 but Home team has won & covered L/2. LY CM (+7) led 13-0 HT and held on for a 16-14 win finishing with 307-184 yd edge. CM is 5-3 SU & ATS (playing for bowl elig) while WM is 4-4 SU & 6-2 ATS. Both are 3-1 SU & ATS in MAC play with the winner staying in the MAC race. Both beat UMass: CM (-16') won 38-13 with a 502-292 yd edge. WM (-12') won 21-3 with a 380-260 yd edge. Both are on a 4-1 SU & ATS run with CM (-7') losing at Akron 28-22 (down 28-10 3Q) & WM (+2) losing 26-17 at Miami (led 17-9 3Q). WM has played tougher schedule (#92-121) has big edge on Def (#55-95) & ST (#50-103). This is a rivalry game but Broncos are the better team overall & off tough loss.

Army by 4 over AIR FORCE - Since '17, Army 6-2 SU & ATS vs AF (falcons avg 9ppg last 8 mtgs). Under on 11-0 run (avg 27ppg). Falcons' offense hopes to challenge history. They avg 36ppg and 114 ypg more than defenses avg (#12 FBS). QB Liam Szarka has emerged with 8-3 ratio (most AF td passes since '19) and team-high 726 rush yds (5.6). However, AF 2-5 because D gives up 37ppg and allows opps to gain 108 yds above their avg (#136 FBS). Falcons 1-6 ATS last 7 after bye. Before break, they beat Wyoming, 24-21, to snap 5gm losing streak. Army 3-4 SU & ATS with 4 straight ATS losses off bye. Knights 3-1 ATS on the road, upsetting Kansas St, beating UAB and losing by just 7 to Tulane. Army is the opposite of AF. They allow 24ppg and hold opp 70ypg below

their avg (#28 FBS), but have not been the same without Bryson Daily (#122 ypp). Army owns blueprint for stuffing AF. They'll keep the Falcons in check and grind out a close win.

TEXAS by 10 over Vanderbilt - LY Texas was -17' and beat a ranked Vandy team 27-24 w/a 392-269 yd edge. Arch Manning looked like the guy he was hyped up to be LW when he threw for 346 yards and 3 td's as he led Texas to a comeback from 17 points down and won 45-38 (-7'). Vandy is now 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS and beat Mizzou LW but only put up 265 yards and Mizzou had to play w/o QB Pribula after he broke his leg on a 4th down stop at the goal line. Manning left w/a concussion LW but could return. Texas has played a much tougher sked (#21 vs #50). Texas has 17 sacks in their last 3 games led by stud DE Collin Simmons. It's hard to believe that this is Texas' first home game in over a month and their SEC home opener! Longhorns still have playoff hopes and a win here sets up a huge game at Georgia in 2 weeks. Texas is laying under a fg and if Arch plays then we love the Longhorns at home.

ILLINOIS by 6 over Rutgers - Rutgers has lost 4 of last 5 to Illinois (1-4 ATS) but has won 2 of last 3 in Champaign. Last time here in '21, Knights pitched 2H shutout & won 20-14. Illini lead series 6-3 SU & ATS, including SU wins in 4 of last 5. LY in Piscataway, Illinois (+2) trailed 17-15 after 3Q, but won 38-31 on Altmeyer TD pass with :04 left. Rutgers opened 3-0 but started 0-4 in B10 play. They did lead both Minnesota & Washington at the half but the defense was allowing 509 ypg in conference play. LW, Rutgers used a FG with :00 left to beat Purdue, 27-24 (+3). Illinois was considered a playoff contender at the start of the year and opened 3-0, but were thrashed by Indiana, 62-10. They upset USC as a HD 34-32, despite losing a pair of fumbles into the EZ for TBs. They lost at home to Ohio St, 34-16, but had a 295-272 yd edge. LW, Washington defeated Illinois 42-25 (-3) and had 440-337 yd edge, meaning their playoff bubble has burst. Bielema is 8-11-1 ATS as a HF with Illinois. Since '20, RU 13-7-2 as AD in B10 games. We like the Illini here.

MINNESOTA by 10 over Michigan St - Spartans 30-19 all-time but have lost last 2 after winning 5 straight from '10-'17. Last time here Sparty (+6) trailed 10-6 at HT but allowed 2 late scores in 27-12 loss. Under HC Fleck, Minn 29-26-1 ATS at home since 2017. Minnesota opened 5-2, 3-1 in B10. LW, Iowa led 31-0 at half en route to a 41-3 win over Minnesota (-7'). Iowa's has won 10 of the last 11 in the rivalry. Iowa had a 166-1 yd edge in 2Q and won 41-3. Mich St opened 3-0 SU but 0-3 ATS. LW RB Haynes returned for Michigan and ran for 152 yards & RB Marshall added 110. QB Underwood hit 8-17-86. Mich St got a TD pass from backup QB Milivojevic with :05 left but lost, 31-20 (+13'). Mich St DC Rossi was Minnesota's DC 2 yrs ago. HC Smith is 17-10 ATS as an AD. Dog is 7-1 ATS in MSU games this yr. Gophers have won back-to-back games and are 9-1 ATS vs Spartans since '05. Gophers have scored last in every game except their szn opnr. We like the Gophers to bounce back here.

IOWA ST by 14 over Arizona St - Major revenge spot for Iowa St, which lost last yr's Big 12 title gm to Arizona St, 45-19. Both tms had the wind come out of their sails in losses last wk. After starting 5-0, Cyclones have dropped 3 straight to Cincy, Colorado & BYU. BYU was in Ames and off a bye, yet ISU was outscored 14-0 in the 4Q of a 41-27 loss. They did outgain the Cougars and have been at least 100yds above opposing defenses avg in 3 of the last 4 gms. ASU, which handed TT its first loss a wk earlier, could not stay hot and lost at home to Houston 24-16. Sun Devils trailed 24-0 in 4Q and QB Sam Leavitt was banged up again, didn't finish and is out this week. Without Leavitt 2 wks ago, ASU lost by 32 at Utah. The D is holding foes 129ypg below their avg (#8 FBS) but the offense averages just 21ppg vs P4. With Leavitt out and star WR Jordyn Tyson hobbled, the attack will get worse before it gets better. ISU gets payback and a DD win to snap the losing skid.

UCONN by 17 over Uab - LY Huskies (-7') won 31-23 despite being outgained 403-365. UAB led 20-3 HT but were outscored 28-3 in 2H allowing L/21 incl front door cover td w/2:39 left. Blazers are 3-4 SU & ATS going into LW's bye but with a interim HC pulled a 31-24 outright upset (+21') over #22 Memphis with both teams starting QB out. UAB is 1-20 SU & 6-14-1 ATS on the road since 2022. UConn is 13-7-1 ATS at home under HC Mora including 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS TY. Huskies re 5-3 SU but 3-4-1 ATS. LW UConn (-10') led Rice 24-17 4Q but lost outright 37-34 in 2OT. UConn has edges on Off (#48-81) & Def (#94-124) and will not look past UAB after their last game. Look for Huskies to bowl eligibility by getting the taste of LW's loss out of their mouth.

BAYLOR by 6 over Ucf - UCF's first trip to Waco. Knights (-9') lost in Orlando, 36-35, in last mtg in '23. UCF comes out of its bye 4-3 and needing 2 more wins for bowl-eligibility in Scott Frost's return to program (Frost 3-7 SU all-time off bye). With Houston, Texas Tech, and BYU still left, Knights will need an upset at some point to earn a bowl berth. They're 0-2 on the road, but did hammer WVU at home before the break, 45-13. The offense averages 208 rush ypg (5.8) and the D is allowing 77 fewer ypg than opponents avg (#25 FBS). That D will get challenged by a Baylor offense avg 34ppg and gaining 94 ypg above opp avg (#18 FBS). Bears led by QB Sawyer Robertson (23-7), but a soft D is why they've slipped to 4-4 with b2b losses to TCU and Cincy. Baylor 15th in Big 12 run D at 191ypg which creates a bad matchup with run-heavy UCF. Bears has faced tougher schedule and wins in Waco, but Knights will slow gm down and stay close for 4Q.

COLORADO by 4 over Arizona - Home team has won last 2 mtgs incl Colorado (+2') last yr in Tucson, 37-7. These 2 are meeting with very different mindsets. Arizona is coming off a bye and looking to reboot after reaching the break with b2b one-score losses to BYU and Houston. Cats are 1-3 SU & ATS over last 4 to fall to 4-3 but are a few plays from being 6-1. Noah Fifita has a 15-4 ratio to give them the QB edge. The D holds opp 81ypg below their avg (#24 FBS) and is #1 in pass eff defense (4-9 ratio) but they allowed 31+ pts in all 3 losses. Colorado, meanwhile, is coming off the worst loss of the HC Sanders era. Buffs got embarrassed in Utah, 53-7, and were outgained 587-140. Prior to Wk 9, they were playing well incl an upset of Iowa St and a 3pt loss to unbeaten BYU. Arizona 0-2 SU & ATS on the road. Colorado 3-0-1 ATS last 4 in Boulder. After hitting rock bottom, Sanders will rally the troops all wk in practice and get back to winning at home.

Washington St by 6 OREGON ST - First of 2 mtg this year to decide the PAC 2 Championship. Have played similar schedules (WSU #32-#43). Cougars are 9-2 SU & 7-4 ATS in series but there have been 4 outright upsets the L/5 years and the Home team has won & covered 4 straight. Beavers are just 1-7 SU (only win over FCS) & 2-6 ATS but are off their first bye of the season. Cougars are 4-4 SU & 5-3 ATS incl 4 straight covers as they upset Colorado St 20-3 (+5'), only lost to #4 Ole Miss 24-21 (+32) & #18 Virginia 22-20 (+17) then LW upset Toledo 28-7 (+1'). With a bye on deck & a huge edge on defense (#40-#93) look for WSU to take care of OSU.

KANSAS ST by 3 over Texas Tech

KANSAS ST (+) over Texas Tech - KSU has won 12 of last 13 in series incl 8 straight (11-2 ATS run). Last 6 in Manhattan, Cats 6-0 and 5-1 ATS vs Texas Tech. KSU is just 4-4 but they're playing at a Big 12 contender level lately. Cats have shaken off 1-3 start to win 3 of last 4, and outgained Baylor in 35-34 loss in Waco. Plus, they're coming of their best effort of the yr, beating rival Kansas, 42-17, in Lawrence (+124yds). The D is #21 against the pass (10-8 ratio) and has held 7 of 8 opp below their ypg avg. At 7-1, TT is still the conf favorite and is +32ppg and +225ypp. However, Red Raiders lost their last road trip (26-22 at ASU with ssn-low 276 yds) and the QB situation has gotten murkier. Will Hammond, who was in for the injured Behren Morton, tore his ACL in Oklahoma St win. Morton was available in an emergency but not 100%. Mitch Griffis was the WF starter in '23 and went 9-13-172-1-0 last wk. Peaking KSU hands TT its second loss of the year.

Virginia by 4 over CALIFORNIA - Virginia makes the long trip to Cal after narrowly escaping their last two games. First meeting and UVA's first trip to the West Coast since 2016. Cal is 5-3 SU/3-5 ATS and -76 ypg vs ACC foes. UVA is is +83 ypg but -85 in their last 4, all close wins. LW we cashed a 3★ going against UVA (-11) and they were outplayed by North Carolina but won on a 2 pt conv in OT. Bears QB JKS only has an 11-7 ratio. Cal is rushing for just 88 (2.9) and their offense avg 31 ypg less than their foes allow on avg (#104). UVA QB Morris has been battling injuries and after avg 540 ypg in their F/5, they avg just 266 ypg the L/3. Wilcox is 14-6 as a home dog. UVA is 10-3 ATS away. Lots of conflicting info so we put this right at the Vegas line.

UNLV by 3 over New Mexico - Last 7 mtgs, home team 1-6 SU & 0-7 ATS. UNLV has had 2 wks to stew over its first loss, 56-31, to Boise St. It was a good chance to regroup and get healthy before MWC stretch run. Before HC Mullen arrived, Rebs were 6-1 ATS last 7 off bye. Their 6-1 start has had smoke & mirrors and they're actually -36ypp in Vegas. Offense is playing well around QB Anthony Colandrea (12-4 ratio), RB Jai'Den Thomas (613, 7.3) and WR Jaden Bradley (528, 18.2). But run D allows 6.0 ypc (#135 FBS). UNLV has huge TO edge here (Rebs #3 in FBS TO margin, Lobos #133). New Mexico 5-3 after b2b home wins over Nevada & Utah St but now hit road where they're 1-3 SU & 2-1-1 ATS. D has held 6 of 8 opp below their avg and just shut down solid Utah St off. Lobos will lean on RB's Damon Bankston & DJ McKinney to control the clock and avoid TOs. UNM, which is playing its 6th straight week, will fall just short against rested Rebs.

Pittsburgh by 21 over STANFORD - Pitt is the hottest team in the ACC since switching to frosh QB Mason Heinschel. Pitt is 4-0 SU/ATS and +85 ypg in their L/4. They are two blown DD leads away from being 8-0. Stanford is 3-5 SU/2-6 ATS though LW they were +30 at Miami, was tied 7-7 at half yet it was 35-7 Miami and the 'Canes scored a 3 yd td for the front door cover with :26 left. Stanford beat FSU in their last home game despite being outgained 444-293 and they are -137 in ACC play. Pitt's D has 19 sacks and should feast on a Stanford Oline that has allowed 24 sacks (9.7%). Narduzzi is 16-5 as AF and Pitt has a bye on deck before a tough final 3 games (ND/GTech/Miami). Panthers won't hold back here.

TROY by 10 over Arkansas St - Troy out for revenge for LY's 34-31 loss in Jonesboro. Home team just 1-8 ATS since 2012 (Troy covered in '23 with 37-3 win). Neither team lost in October. Troy is 6-2 and riding 5-gm win streak. Trojans have been outgained last 3 gms, but are winning with TO's (+6 in those gms) and a defense that's giving up just 24ppg (27 to Clemson & 28 to Memphis). Arkansas St has clawed back to .500 with 3 straight wins. Red Wolves handled Georgia Southern last week, 34-24, behind ssn-high 482yds. Devin Spencer & Kenyon Clay rushed for 100 yds and the healthy return of WR Corey Rucker has helped stoke the passing gm. However, on the road they're 1-3 and -134ypp, and Butch Jones is 6-22 SU on the road as ASU HC. Troy is hotter, home and better equipped to make key stops on defense. Trojans pull away in the 2H for a 10-pt win and their 6th straight overall.

Miami, FI by 4 over SMU - UM is making their first trip to Dallas to play SMU. The only prior meeting was in 1965. Miami is 6-1 SU but they've been unimpressive in their last 2, losing to Louisville and LW they were tied at half with Stanford. Miami pulled away in the 2H and scored a td with :26 left for a front-door cover. They did finish w/a 404-144 yd edge. SMU had their best game two weeks ago when they upset Clemson on the road but LW they put up just 12 points and 246 yards. They still led WF 12-10 but WF hit a 50 yd fg as time expired. SMU is allowing just 96 ypg (2.8). They've given up 304 pass ypg yet are #19 in the Pass D Rankings (57%, 16-12). SMU is 19-4 SU at home yet, are coming off an embarrassing loss and getting DD's here. All the value is on the underdog Mustangs and we think they keep it much closer than expected.

HOUSTON by 21 over West Virginia - Houston won only prior mtg, 41-39, on Hail Mary in '23. Cougars 7-1 with only loss to Big 12 fav Texas Tech. Houston emerged as legit conf contender with LW's 24-16 defeat of ASU in Tempe. Cougs led 24-0 before giving up 16 pts in 4Q. Defense allowing just 19 ppg and 3.4 ypc (#3 in Big 12). Conner Weigman (20 td tot's & 2 INTs) has been a difference-maker for an offense that struggled badly in HC Fritz's debut LY. WVU is rebuilding in Rich Rod's return to the sidelines. Not only is the talent level not there yet, but Mountaineers have been crushed by key injuries. They've lost 5 straight by an avg of 39-16 and they're -209ypp on the road. However, LW's 23-17 home loss to TCU was WVU's best gm since Week 3 upset of Pitt. While Mountaineers are a work in progress, Houston has hit its stride. Cougars will stifle the WVU offense and Weigman will have all day to operate vs a D that's had 1 sack in the last 5 gms.

AUBURN by 10 over Kentucky - Aub has won 5 straight in this series including LY 24-10 (+1) in Lexington. Tigers have covered the L/3 in the series. KY QB Cutter Booley threw for 330 yards LW but their D allowed a ssn high 504 yards as the 'Cats lost 56-34 (+9) vs Tennessee. RB McGowan missed the game. Aub trailed at Ark 24-19 4Q then forced TO's on Ark's L/4 possessions. Aub settled for fg's on their L/5 possessions but won 33-24 (+3). Aub has a big edge on D here, allowing 19 ppg/319 ypg and holding foes 109 ypg below their avg. KY's D is allowing 30p/385 ypg but does hold foes 37 ypg below their avg. 'Cats did outplay Texas 2 wks ago and are 9-6 ATS on the road while Auburn is 4-9 as HF. Aub is still fighting for something and the switch to QB Daniels may help. Tigers D and home field make the difference so Aub by 10.

ARKANSAS by 6 over Mississippi St - Miss St lost LY's meeting 58-25 (+7) but they had covered 5 of the previous 6 and won in '22 and '23. Ark led Auburn 24-19 LW when QB Taylen Green turned into Turnover Green as Ark had TO's on their final 4 possessions and they lost by 9. Hogs D is allowing 501 ypg in their L/4 and 242 rush ypg in their L/5. Miss St was 4-0 in Non-Conf play but they've lost their L/4 and Leiby is 0-12 SU vs the SEC. Bulldogs are allowing 456 ypg in their L/4 and are -79 ypg in SEC play. They are also rushing for just 121 (2.8) vs the SEC foes and they've allowed 20 sacks in those. It's hard to trust either team but Ark is +11 ypg vs the SEC and they do have 4 close losses to ranked teams. Hogs are -4' and we think Ark finally wins a close game.

NORTH TEXAS by 14 over Navy - Navy won both previous meetings including in '23 but didn't cover as 6' point HF, 27-24. Navy is 7-0 SU but 2-5 ATS and we've gone against them as DD chalk in each of their last 4 games and they are 0-4 in those. NT saw the option earlier this year when they beat Army 45-38 (-2). The Mean Green are 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS. QB Mestamaker threw for 608 yards and 4 td's LW at CLT. The game was tied 17-17 at half and NT only led 27-20 4Q when they rattled off 4 straight scoring drives for a misleading blow out. Navy QB Horvath has 814 rush (6.8) and 1,063 pass (65%, 7-3). Navy's pass D is #112, allowing 257 ypg (63%, 12-4) and they just allowed 345 and 381 in their L/2 gms. There will be a lot of points here and Navy will once again struggle with a potent pass attack so we are calling for the home team to win by 2 td's.

Old Dominion by 17 over ULM - First meeting. Old Dominion got back on track with last week's 24-21 win over App St. Monarchs led 24-7 in 4Q and outgained Mountaineers 459-374. The win stopped the bleeding after b2b blowout road losses to Marshall and JMU. Led by dual-threat QB Colton Joseph (19-9 ratio, 548, 6 td's rushing), ODU gaining 120ypp above opp avg (#10 FBS). Joseph & Co. will be a problem for a ULM D allowing foes 75ypp above their avg (#126 FBS). Since jumping out to a 3-1 start, Warhawks have lost 4 in a row by avg score of 37-13. The defense is struggling but the offense has hit a wall as well. Three of the last 4 opponents have averaged more than 5 ypc which will get exposed this week. ODU may not be the team that beat Virginia Tech by 19 and Coastal Carolina by 40 earlier in the year, but they're also not the team that collapsed in b2b losses. Somewhere in between is enough to beat fading ULM by 17.

KANSAS by 31 over Oklahoma St - While Oklahoma St is playing out the string, Kansas still has visions of a bowl gm after missing out on the postseason last yr. The 4-4 Jayhawks have lost their last 2 gms including a 17th straight Sunflower Showdown to rival KSU that they were favored to win. They were thoroughly outplayed in 42-17 home loss. The last 3 gms after a KSU loss, KU is 3-0 SU & ATS incl epic 2021 upset of Texas, 57-56, as 31pt dog. With Arizona, Iowa St and Utah on deck, Jayhawks must take care of business here against the league's worst team. Things just keep getting worse for the Cowboys who've lost 7 straight and whose fan base is most concerned with the identity of the next coach. In 5 conf gms, they've been outscored 43-15 and outgained 474-278. OSU is 135th in pass efficiency D with a 21-3 ratio, so this will be a big gm for QB Jalon Daniels (18-3 ratio). Without much fight left, Cowboys will bow to the Jayhawks in a blowout.

OLE MISS by 7 over South Carolina - Ole Miss has won the L/2 in the series. LY Ole Miss won 27-3 (-9') with a 425-313 yd edge. SC is dangerously close to missing out on a bowl at 3-5 though all 5 losses are to ranked teams. LW they were on the verge of upsetting Bama then allowed 2 td's in the last 2:16 and lost 29-22. Ole Miss is +37 ypg vs the SEC while SC is -40. Ole Miss has a big edge on offense, led by QB Chambliss (9-1 ratio) while SC has the edge on D, led by DE Dylan Stewart (3.5 sk) and the Gamecocks have a solid ST's edge. This is exactly the kind of game where the Rebels have a letdown and Ole Miss is 0-4 ATS the week after they pull an upset under Lane Kiffin. SC keeps it within a score.

LIBERTY by 10 over Delaware - First meeting. Lib is 3-4 but only 1 of those losses are in CUSA play so the Flames are still in contention in CUSA. They are +95 ypg in CUSA play and are off B2B wins, beating UTEP 19-8 w/a 403-167 yd edge and 2 weeks ago they rallied to beat NMST 30-27 (+10') in OT. Del is 4-3 in their first FBS season. The Blue Hens are 2-2 SU/ATS (+34 ypg) in CUSA play with wins over FIU and Middle Tenn and losses to WKU and Jax St. LW they were outgained 384-360 at home and beat MT 31-28. Liberty has the edge on defense and ST's. They are 15-2 SU at home yet laying just over a fg so we will take the more motivated team, home team to win by double-digits.

WKU by 11 over New Mexico St - WKU won LY's meeting 41-28 but didn't cover (-17') and NMST actually had the ydg edge 460-413. NMST has lost 4 of their L/5 and they are -64 ypg vs CUSA foes. WKU is 6-2 and just beat LA Tech 28-27 on the road. They are 4-1 in CUSA play but -26 ypg and the D is allowing 409 ypg and 75 ypg more than their foes avg (#128). WKU has a big edge on offense, putting up 30 ppg/407 ypg while NMST avg just 22 ppg/319 ypg. NMST is -114 ypg on the road and Tony Sanchez is 1-8 SU/3-6 ATS on the road while WKU is 8-2 SU/7-3 ATS the L/2Y at home. We will take the better offense at home and laying single-digits.

Hawaii by 3 SAN JOSE ST - SJ St has won 4 straight in series (2-2 ATS). Under cashed all 4 gms (avg 41ppg). Both tms off bye (Hawaii has won & covered b2b off bye/SJSt 3-0 SU but 1-2 ATS under HC Brennan). Warriors 6-2 and bowl-eligible for first time since '21. They've won 3 straight and are 6-1 ATS vs FBS. A healthy QB Micah Alejado has thrown for 1,516 yds and a 9-2 ratio during win streak. He's the key to HC Chang's offense. Hawaii #66 in pass eff D (9-5 ratio), which will be crucial in a gm with 2 of the league's top passers. This is a pivotal gm for 2-5 SJ St. Spartans lost b2b road gms to Utah St & Wyoming, but return home with a 2-1 mark in San Jose and have only been outgained twice. Six of their 7 gms have decided by 1 score (lost to Texas 38-7). QB Walker Eget (15-3 ratio) has only been sacked 8 times and he gives Spartans a slight off edge. But the defense allows opp 76 more ydg than their avg (#127 FBS) and the pass D ranks #123 overall and #130 in ypa. Alejado outduels Eget, dropping SJ St to 2-5 in 1-score gms.

4★ DETROIT over Minnesota – MIN fell hard on TNF, routed 37-10 by LAC while being held to just 161 total yds and only 4 on the ground, as QB Carson Wentz threw a pick before going down to season-ending IR. That leaves rookie JJ McCarthy in line to start, though he inherits a unit averaging just 296 ypg (#26) and one of the league's weakest rushing attacks. DET comes in off a bye after rolling to 30.7 ypg (#3), and they've owned this series at 9-0 ATS. The Lions' defense also sits top 10 in yds and pts allowed, while trends back them strongly with a 13-3 ATS mark after SU wins of 14+. MIN has dropped 5 straight ATS after giving up 30+, and their road struggles vs winning teams (0-3-1 ATS) continue to loom. With DET rested and far more complete on both sides, this sets up as another decisive win.

FORECAST: DETROIT by 17

3★ BUFFALO over Kansas City – KC comes off a 28-7 win over WSH where QB Patrick Mahomes threw for 299 yds and 3 TDs, but that marks two straight weeks against struggling opponents. Now they step up in class, heading on the road to face BUF this week before DEN next week in what will be a tougher stretch. The Bills are off a bye with QB Josh Allen leading an offense averaging 383 ypg and 29.6 ppg, and they've owned the recent series with a 4-0 SU/ATS mark in the regular season vs KC. BUF also thrives against winning teams at 6-1 ATS, and catching points at home makes them an attractive play. This matchup has been a must-watch in recent years, and with BUF rested and balanced on both sides, they are set up well to get it done again.

FORECAST: BUFFALO by 4

2★ LA Chargers by 17 over TENNESSEE – TEN fell 38-14 at IND where their defense surrendered 525 yds, including 153 on the ground to RB Jonathan Taylor, while QB Cam Ward was under pressure throughout and threw a costly INT. The Titans sit dead last in both total offense (249 ypg) and scoring (13.8 ppg), and have now failed to cover in 7 straight after scoring under 15. LAC comes off a dominant 37-10 TNF win over MIN behind QB Justin Herbert (3 TD, 122.8 rating) and RB Kimani Vidal (117 yds), and their defense limited the Vikings to just 161 total yds. The Chargers are top 5 in offensive yds (378 ypg) and top 10 in defense, and have been cashing tickets with 5 straight ATS wins after holding opponents under 15 pts. Trends also point heavily to the Over with TEN 5-0-1 in that spot after allowing 350+ yds, but LAC's firepower vs a struggling TEN defense (29 ppg allowed) makes the side even stronger.

FORECAST: LA Chargers by 17

OTHER PLAYS

Baltimore vs MIAMI – TNF – BAL leaned on RB Derrick Henry (71 yds, 2 TD) to beat CHI last week, with QB Tyler Huntley keeping things steady while Lamar Jackson sat out. Jackson's expected return gives the Ravens an added spark, but the defense continues to sit near the bottom of the league at 30 ppg allowed. MIA comes in off a dominant 34-10 TNF win over ATL, where QB Tua Tagovailoa tossed 4 TDs and the defense forced an early turnover to seize control. With both offenses capable of striking quickly and defenses that have shown cracks, this Halloween-even matchup has the look of one that could turn into a treat for fans looking for fireworks under the primetime lights. ***Get the Thursday Night NFL Marquee online at ncsports.com or call the office at 1-800-654-3448 after 12:00 noon ET.**

CINCINNATI by 4 over Chicago – CHI slipped to 3-3 after a 30-16 loss at BAL where QB Caleb Williams threw for 285 yds but tossed a key INT, and the ground game managed only 69 yds between RB D'Andre Swift (45 yds, 1 TD) and RB Kyle Monangai (24 yds). The Bears still average 350 ypg but continue to allow 26 ppg. CIN comes off an embarrassing 39-38 collapse to NYJ, blowing a late lead despite QB Joe Flacco going 21/34 for 223 yds and 2 TDs, RB Samaje Perine rushing for 94 yds and a score, and WR Ja'Marr Chase pulling in 12 catches for 91 yds on 19 targets. The Bengals defense, gashed for 500+ yds, held a players-only meeting this week, and with pride on the line they are expected to respond. With both teams trending heavily to the Over and CIN looking to redeem itself in front of the home crowd, this has all the makings of a high-scoring bounce-back spot for the Bengals.

NY GIANTS by 3 over San Francisco – The 49ers head east for B2B road games after being held to just 218 yards in Houston. With both Brock Purdy and Mac Jones questionable, and WR Ricky Pearsall still uncertain, SF's offense could again be limited. Their defense allows just 20.5 ppg but has given up 337 ypg and has struggled in spots against balanced attacks. NYG comes off a 38-20 loss at PHI where Jaxson Dart threw for 193 yards and a TD despite being sacked 5 times. The Giants have been a strong home ATS team (4-0 last 4 off an ATS loss, 4-1-1 last 6 at home vs winning road team), while SF has failed in these situations (1-7 ATS after <90 rush yards, 2-10 ATS after an ATS win). With Cam Skattebo done for the year, Tyrone Tracy Jr. will handle more of the RB load, and Wan'Dale Robinson remains a key target. Given SF's QB uncertainty and travel spot, the Giants are positioned to grind out a narrow home win in a matchup that could see points traded both ways.

NEW ENGLAND by 10 over Atlanta – ATL comes in limping after a 34-10 blowout loss at MIA where QB Kirk Cousins threw for 173 yds with no TDs and the run game mustered only 39 yds, while Bijan Robinson also lost a fumble. The Falcons' offense averages just 17 ppg (#28), and with QB Michael Penix and WR Drake London both questionable again, the unit's ceiling looks capped. NE rolled CLE 32-13 behind QB Drake Maye's sharp outing (18/24, 282 yds, 3 TD) and RB TreVeyon Henderson's 75 rush yds. The Patriots' defense has been steady, allowing only 18 ppg (#4), and Cousins looking the way he did should struggle if starting again. NE is 5-0 ATS vs losing teams and riding a 5-game cover streak, while ATL is just 1-7-1 ATS after allowing 30+. Given how one team is heating up while the other is searching for answers, the Patriots' balance on both sides of the ball points to another double-digit win at home.

Indianapolis by 3 over PITTSBURGH – IND comes in red hot off a 38-14 rout of TEN where Daniel Jones threw for 272 yds and 3 TDs while RB Jonathan Taylor broke free for 153 rush yds and 2 TDs, including an 80-yd score. The Colts lead the league in both total offense (385 ypg) and scoring (34 ppg), and their attack has been consistent through the air and on the ground. PIT is fresh off a 35-25 loss to GB despite 219 pass yds and 2 TDs from Aaron Rodgers, but their defense gave up 421 total yds and a breakout performance from TE Tucker Kraft. The Steelers have now dropped 4 of their last 5 ATS vs winning teams, while IND has covered 8 of 10 after holding opponents under 15 pts. The Colts' top-ranked offense will be tested by a PIT unit that thrives on turnover margin, but the matchup projects to favor IND slightly in what could be a competitive, higher-scoring game.

GREEN BAY by 10 over Carolina – The Packers are fresh off a comeback win at PIT where QB Jordan Love threw for 360 yds and 3 TDs, with TE Tucker Kraft emerging for 143 yds and 2 TDs. GREEN BAY sits top-10 in both offense (359 ypg, 27.6 ppg) and defense (289 ypg, 21.4 ppg), giving them balance at home. Carolina was overwhelmed 40-9 by BUF, surrendering 7 sacks while QB Andy Dalton threw for just 175 yds; WR Tetiairoa McMillan was the lone spark with 99 yds. QB Bryce Young may return, but this offense has been stuck under 20 pts in 5 of 6 games. Trends lean heavily toward points, with CAR hitting the over in 6 straight after <150 pass yds and GREEN BAY cashing 4 straight

overs, setting up Lambeau for another scoring day. CAR is good with garbage time points sitting at #6 in 4Q scoring vs GB sitting at #28 4Q scoring allowed which sets this up to have CAR cover late. **HOUSTON by 3 over Denver** – This game matches strength on strength, with DEN ranking top 10 in both offense (357 ypg, 25.9 ppg) and defense (281 ypg, 18.9 ppg), but traveling into the league's top-rated defense as HOUSTON allows just 267 ypg and 14.7 ppg. Rookie QB Bo Nix tossed 4 TDs in DEN's 44-24 rout of DAL, while RB RJ Harvey added 3 scores, showing this offense can hit big plays. HOUSTON leaned on QB C.J. Stroud's arm again, posting 318 pass yds and 2 TDs in a 26-15 win over SF, proving they can control games without much ground support. Trends point toward a grinder: HOU are 5-1 ATS vs AFC foes and 6-0-1 to the Under after 350+ yds, while DEN has cashed Overs in 9 of 10 vs losing teams. With DEN's secondary losing CB Patrick Surtain, Stroud could find opportunities downfield, but both defenses are capable of keeping things tight.

Jacksonville by 7 over LAS VEGAS – Both teams return from the bye, but LAS VEGAS continues to struggle mightily on offense (14.7 ppg, #31; 276 ypg, #30). Jacksonville's balance gives them the statistical edge, with their defense ranking stronger against the run. Raiders may get WR Jakobi Meyers and TE Brock Bowers back, but the passing game has lacked consistency. Meanwhile, JAX WR Travis Hunter has become a key weapon, posting 8 catches for 101 yds and 1 TD in his last outing — and bigger numbers can be expected here against a shaky secondary. Even on the road, Jacksonville looks primed to control this matchup, with their offensive playmakers and defensive steadiness carrying the edge.

LA RAMS by 11 over New Orleans – Rookie QB Tyler Shough steps in for NO, bringing some fresh momentum after a messy showing vs TB. The Saints have playmakers like Olave and Shaheed, but they're averaging just 16.0 ppg and now face one of the league's best defenses in LAR (#3 scoring D at 16.7 ppg allowed). The Rams, meanwhile, get Puka Nacua back to spark an already balanced attack. Still, history shows LAR are 0-4 ATS in their last four after a bye, and that trend sets the stage for NO to hang on just enough to cover the big number, even if the Rams control the game flow.

Seattle vs WASHINGTON – SNF – SEA comes off a bye with a 3-0 SU/ATS road mark this season, leaning on Sam Darnold to manage the offense while Kenneth Walker provides balance in the run game. WASHINGTON is in primetime for a second straight week and should get Jayden Daniels back, which could spark an offense that struggled to find rhythm in last week's loss outside of McLaurin's lone TD grab. SEA's defense has quietly held opponents under 20 ppg, but WSH has been strong at home (5-1 ATS last six), and with the Over cashing in eight of WSH's last nine home games, this one sets up as another SNF matchup that could stay tight into the 4th quarter. ***Get the Sunday Night NFL Marquee online at ncsports.com or call the office at 1-800-654-3448 after 11:00am ET.**

Arizona vs DALLAS – MNF – The Cardinals come off a bye with Kyler Murray expected back, which adds intrigue to this primetime clash. ARI has covered 4 straight on the road, but their struggles on MNF (1-4 ATS last five) loom large. DALLAS has dropped two in a row and its defense has been shredded (allowing 31 ppg, #31), though the offense still ranks #2 in both YPG (384.1) and scoring (30.8 ppg). With the Over cashing in five straight for DAL and nine of the last eleven for ARI vs losing teams, fireworks are likely under the lights. Recent H2H history favors the Cardinals (3-0 SU/ATS last five years), but with DAL sitting with #2 YPG/PPG their offense could overturn the series history.
